



EDITORIAL

Welcome to a new volume of Awareness! At the time of writing, we are planning to get this edition printed professionally together with the latest UFO Register. Whether this will be successful remains to be seen. The majority of members subscriptions are due at this time of year. If yours is amongst these, the secretary will be enclosing a renewal slip. All members should receive 4 copies of Awareness for each subscription, but we no longer tie everybody's membership to a March 31st renewal basis. We are pleased to say the subscription will remain unchanged for 1989-90 at only £6. Donations are most gratefully received over and above this amount.

The current level of UFO activity in the Oxford area is very low with little to report in the first three months of the year 1989. However indications of sightings in other areas are to be found from East Anglia and the West Country in particular. The only National Headline was in the Daily Star on March 30th which claimed the American Space Shuttle, Discovery, was tracked by a UFO while in orbit, which caused a major power failure on board. Strangely, no other paper reported this incident.

Those who adhere to the "sunspot theory"- that UFO activity rapidly increases when the sun becomes very active as indicated by the number of sunspots on the surface - may be rewarded in 1990-1. Based on the 11 year maximum, we were expecting the next peak in 1989-90 after the great surge of UFO activity in 1977-8, but this may now be 1990-1 according to the Astronomical Year Book published for 1989. Of course the 11 year cycle is subject to fluctuations. Some indication of high activity on the sun was indicated by a recent show of the Aurora Borealis or "northern lights" in Southern England where it is a rare phenomenon. Happily this sighting occurred on a Monday evening in March when Contact's data research group were meeting in Oxford, so they were lucky to see the Aurora at about 9.45 p.m. At the time the pink shafts of light were not readily identified, but press reports the following morning confirmed it was the Aurora, and it had been witnessed as far south as Southampton.

Several research groups have been completing their work on the "rings in cornfield" phenomena". The rings have appeared regularly since 1980 in southern England mainly, and explanations have come forth thick and fast ranging from pure hoaxes and UFOs to the latest "holes in the ozone layer" theory. The most satisfactory explanation would seem to be the unusual wind vortex theory. Strange behaviour in the system of winds prevailing over the U.K maybe caused by modern pollutants or the like somehow create the ring formations. Just why the rings are so perfectly regular remains a mystery. Nobody appears to have witnessed a ring in the actual process of being created - so they probably generate in the middle of the night. Contact Int has not spent a great deal of time in studying this subject, but if anyone reading this has any additional facts, would they please inform Data Research at group headquarters.

Thanks to those members who responded to our survey. A few more of their sightings are reported on pages 13-14.

## UFOLOGICAL ILLUSIONS - PLANETRY GUIDE 1989

By G.E. Ambler

The positions of the brightest planets are charted annually on a monthly basis to aid investigators in the elimination of erroneous UFO sightings. During 1989 Venus and Jupiter will be the brightest objects, Mars gradually fading away from a maximum brightness in September 1988.

Of the eight other planets in the solar system, the five innermost are bright enough to be seen by the average viewer. Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto are too distant to stand out in the sky.

The general movements are listed below:-

**MERCURY:** The nearest planet to the sun can only be seen infrequently and then only close to the setting or rising sun. During 1989 it can be seen from British latitudes from January 3rd for 2 weeks in the evening twilight. A further period of visibility occurs in the second half of April and the first 2 weeks in May again the evening twilight. During the first three weeks of October Mercury will appear just before sunrise.

**VENUS:** When visible, Venus will always appear very bright. In January it will be a morning object but disappears from view in the last week of the month. It will reappear in May as an evening object becoming progressively brighter and longer in the sky towards the end of the year.

**MARS:** Can be seen in evening skies from January to June, becoming fainter each month. It will reappear as a morning star in December but again quite a faint object.

**JUPITER:** The planet is a very bright object in the evening sky from January to mid May and thereafter not visible until July when it re-appears as a morning object becoming brighter towards the end of the year. In November and December it will be seen all night, and reach its opposition (brightest) on December 27th.

**SATURN:** Becomes visible as a morning object from March. It will increase in visibility during the year to August being best on July 2nd when it is in opposition with the ring system fully open. It declines as an evening object until November.

### YEARLY TABLE

The positions of these planets and the brightest star SIRIUS is tabulated below month by month. The magnitude or brightness of the object is given where known. The more negative the value the brighter will be the object. The following is a rough guide to comparative brightness.

-3.1 to -5.0	brilliant
-2.1 to -3.0	very bright
0 to -2.0	bright

+0.1 to +1.0 just noticeable from background stars.  
Greater than +1.0, average stars not standing out.

The polestar and satellites in orbit have a magnitude around +2. On this scale the sun is estimated at -26.

Eclipses: There are 4 eclipses of the sun or moon in 1989, only one of which is visible from British Latitudes. This is a total eclipse of the moon on August 17th from 01.21-04.55. The period of totality will be 02.20 - 03.56. Unfortunately most people will be in bed at these times. (We received photographic evidence of a UFO at the same time as an eclipse of the moon about 3 years ago).

### Hypothetical Cases:

- 1) A bright shining object seen low down to the west on October 5th at 7.00 p.m. -Most probably Venus, unless Venus was seen as a separate object.
- 2) A bright red object seen overhead on May 10th at 10.00 p.m. -Could be Mars, but this is now very faint. If moving, could be an aircraft, but most likely as "unexplained".
- 3) Brilliant white object seen overhead at midnight on August 10th Venus, Jupiter and Mars are all missing on this date, so object may be UFO. Very few other bright stars are visible in the summer sky.
- 4) Bright pulsating white object seen to the East at midnight on November 5th.- Sounds like Sirius rising behind the constellation Orion. Check if witness has knowledge of astronomical features.

### AIDS FOR INVESTIGATORS!

#### A POINTS SYSTEM FOR UFO REPORTS

The 50 or so reports coming into Contact International per month from near and far are of very various quality. It would be nice to be able to quantify the strength of a report before spending time investigating it. The Police in Britain have just introduced a points system to enable them to decide rationally which cases to send the C.I.D. to, and which to just file and ignore. The system outlined here has a similar use and can similarly supply a figure of merit - more than ten being a strong sighting. The categories on which decisions are made are are:-

For Example:-

A midnight sighting by an untrained observer from an Official Source merits only six points - but a landing near powerlines by a single trained observer with landing-traces merits 13 points.

The method is simple - circle those statements on the accompanying chart which are true of the sighting and no others and add all the numbers near them. Under each heading the points are alternatives, so that not more than one is circled.

The system is most useful in deciding what order to investigate reports in, and a number of copies of this form are useful.

♥ M.I.B.S. or Men in BLUE Suits!

For many years one sort of humanoid has appeared in CE 111 reports: associated with the UFO has been a blond male, apparently of Scandinavian origin who has descended out of the blue to talk with witnesses. Of course, mythically, angels are blond and come from heaven which was considered in old times to be beyond the sky, and this can be seen in heaven or sky illustrations from early times. What we are considering here is a much more recent phenomenon, but perhaps one which has the same resonances. The colour vocabulary of people is not precise but I shall use the term 'cerulean' to denote this shade, although the terminology of the witnesses is less clear.

In March 1979 a thirty-two year old medical assistant had gone to make a phone call from near the Co-op when a grey disc with a dome appeared over a near-by fish-shop. She could see inside two ufonauts looking out of one side of the disc. One occupant had his arms behind his back as if bored. Outside everything was still. They had blond hair and although seeming to be from beyond the sky appeared nordic with their long locks. This UFO was a strange encounter because it happened, had two witnesses and occurred in an urban area. Which really makes one wonder is what the ufonauts in their sky-disc were doing. The UFO had a very large transparent window so was obviously for observation duty. Inside the UFO, the blonds had ice-blue suits on.

There is always in respect of sky-phenomena a duality between the physical phenomenon and the psychical projection which colours memories and perceptions about phenomena in the sky. The fact that these occupants appeared bored in their ski-suits, watching a relatively still outer world is a practical note which gives this report some weight. Apart from this Sheffield case there was another case with blond men apparently from beyond the sky at Ranton, Staffs. on 21st October 1954. Can we conclude from the numerous cases with nordic types that there is a nordic base of operations for UFOs? Another odd fact is the similarity of these two cases, separated by 25 years; another example of twinning which occurred in 1958 consists of the Loch Raven Dam case of 26th October 1958 and the Pont-la-Dame case which occurred on 28th October 1958, in both cases the object hovered above an iron bridge and in both cases the ignition of a car was affected.

These blond figures in cerulean ski-suits in these two cases seemed to be observers. In the 1954 case Mrs Jessie Roestenberg and her sons Anthony and Ronald, rushed outside at the sound of a jet plane to observe it but saw instead a disc containing two ufonauts. They rushed inside and hid under the table. Time seemed to pass incredibly slowly and Mrs Roestenberg felt paralysed. The paralysis was felt outside before she hid. The object gave off a purple flash of light and disappeared. Since that time in common with many close contact cases she has found herself to be psychic(3), this appears to be a physical bi-product of close proximity. The blue suited characters looked down with a certain compassion and wistfulness through the large window of the disc. There is a numinous effect (aura) of things seen in the sky, for psychological reasons, but this seems to be well beyond any effect like that. The blond watched and

outside everything became perfectly still.

An occupant like this has been seen by himself; in close proximity to a witness in Cordoba, Argentina, June 1968 at Motel La Cuesta on Highway 20 which connects Villa Carlos Paz with Eastern Argentina. At 12.50 a.m. on 13th June 1968 the proprietor, Senor Pretzel, was returning when he saw 50 metres beyond the Motel on the road a machine beaming two bright lights (red) at the Motel. He ran to the Motel and found his daughter lying in a dead faint on the floor.

She said that she had just said goodnight to her boyfriend when she was flooded with light and she saw a six foot tall entity (apparently connected with the UFO outside); above his hand floated a sphere and on his finger was a large ring. Here again the possibility of a nordic link presents itself, because his eyes were the colour of the sky and so was the ball. The occupant's suit was blue and seemed scaly. He seemed like a patch of sky or a picture. The ufonaut emanated a feeling of goodness and kindness. Light came from his ring and he moved it up and down constantly in front of her. She felt strength draining from her body and was filled with lethargy in front of the smiling stranger. As she collapsed to the floor he left by the side door to return to his sky-disc (or more properly, object). The strange visitor was gone. He was blond too. What is really going on here? This action was much more dynamic than the other cases and we have the common factors of the colour of the uniform, the compassionate demeanour and the blue eyes and blond hair.

There is also the stillness of the scene outside in the first two cases that Jenny Randles has twinned together suggesting that in some way they may just be one event. Do these occupants come from UFOs released from some Nordic Base, or are they celestial? Do they wear cerulean blue for an indicator of mission, or because they like the pictures it makes? The ufonauts against the blue blue backdrop of the sky present a duality between what they are and what we project on them. They may come hyperdimensionally from the 'back of the sky' but whatever the model we adopt for these men suited in blue: our sky-blonds pose an enigma.

♥ EDUARD MEIER - An Appraisal

My contentions for the Eduard Meier Case of photographs & contacts being genuine.

Of course as all the information about him is second-hand through books written by Elders, Welch and Stevens, Gary Kinder and many, many articles by other American UFOlogists and world-wide who have added their twopenny bits in, for - and against; mine also just add to the accumulative mass of opinions. We will never really know

whether this case, George Adamski's and countless others world-wide who claim to be Contactees, have contact with Extraterrestrials that really occur in our terms of reality. That they genuinely occurred to the Contactee's mind as a physical reality, there is no doubt in a few thousand cases which were carefully vetted by Nationally controlled, scientifically orientated Organisations and individuals who are genuine, qualified UFOlogist Investigators.

There are accredited good Investigators, such Mrs. Stella Lansing (USA) and others who are repeater Witnesses /and/or Contactees themselves, but these, including myself, are in a very small minority. So therefore it might interest others, that I give these views bracketed in that category.

1. All the experts in their particular field of photography etc., both in the USA and Europe who examined the Meier photographs were people at the top of their professions, and successful business-wise. So one can safely assume they have the money to pursue their own interests and buy what they need for themselves within reason. This type of middle-class professional person, has absolutely NO conception of, or even begin to understand real grinding poverty, such as families living on Social Security, have to endure. You can be sure it happens in the field of UFO investigating. I was brought up in well-off comfortable British middle-class colonialism, in later life married into a working-class environment and now through misfortune of my husband being disabled, live on Social Security, so that is why I view the findings and opinions of these experts as somewhat irrelevant to the fact that any of them even begin to perceive rural mountain poverty.

Eduard Meier lived in a small mountain village called Hinwel, existing with his wife and children on Swiss Social Security (anywhere in the world these are unrealistic and inadequate) plus pin money from the sale of eggs and the occasional pig. This had to feed, clothe and provide every necessity for his children and a large old house, there was little left for clothes for himself and his wife, let alone expensive elaborate photography material, and also realistic convincing materials to make model UFOs. Gary Kinder in his 'Light Years' points this out. As far as I know, and I have read a lot about this case, none of these experts were even aware of or gave thought to the nitty-gritties of this poor family man's background and living.

Here in North Wales, I live in a small rural mountain village, everyone knows when you go out, what you buy and so on. Whats more, a lot of my life I have lived in mountains, here, the Spanish Pyrenees and the Himalayas. Rural mountain villagers are all basically the same, suspicious of outsiders and very self-contained. Eduard Meier broke the mould by travelling in the Far-East, living a short time in India and other countries. On returning he brought a foreign wife, a Greek. In a village like Hinwel a handicap. The British on the whole, are far more tolerant of "living and let living" than Europeans. I've lived in Spain, France and in the days of British India, we had a large contingent of Swiss living in the Himalayas, usually they were in the confectionary business. You can be sure the Hinwel villagers and all the other little villages around them gave extra vigilance to watching the coming and goings of the odd-bod fellow Swiss and his foreigner wife. Yet despite this and later the vast amount of publicity given the case in Switzerland, Germany and Austria, plus other European countries, no photographer or other Shop-Keeper ever came forward to say Meier had ever bought or sent

for in the post-material to make model UFOs or expensive photography equipment either. Beatrice and Willy Bar, owners of Bar Photo in the next small village/town of Wetzikon which is described as 'a downtown shopping strip' by Gary Kinder, together with the former owner of the Photo Shop, Fritz Kindliman who had processed Meier's films from 1973 onwards, agreed that they had processed and handled all Meier's photographs, they were certain they were genuine. Willy Bar said "I never saw anything suspicious in the black and white films I developed, nor was I ever told to manipulate anything". He, "carefully examined all the Films with a magnifying glass and was certain there were no double exposures".

Add to this the practical consideration that with one arm Meier could never have dangled a model UFO out over mountain ridges, and held and posed his type of simple camera at the same time. Innumerable people were guests at his house, none saw any other camera equipment. There were a couple of small model UFOs, which Meier showed them, which he said he copied from what he had seen. He also photographed them at his second Farm House at Schmidruti. All these have been clumped together by unscrupulous 'experts' in order to prove the case a hoax. In my opinion numbers of the Meier photos are genuine, possibly also his contacts with the A lien - but, like so many Contactees, including people I have investigated myself, they then embroider in order to desperately prove their experience, or alternatively, for the more sinister reason, these Contactees minds can be manipulated by The Visitors.


The American Colonel Wendelle Stevens visited the Meier home on many occasions and says "It just got to the point where one man couldn't have done so much so well to fool so many people for so long".

This has also been my conclusion after reading innumerable articles Against and some for Eduard Meier. As to whether Semjase of the Pleiades duped Meier, is another matter, it seems to me that all these Contactees all over the World who relate fantastic and oft time nonsensical conversations with Space People are being used as dupes - to what purpose? We may never find out in our lifetimes. The general build-up of implications are quite frightening.

My contention is, that when endeavouring to Study and even understand a little, these out -of-this-world Contacts, we should firstly keep our feet very firmly on the ground and judge with a good dollop of common sense. Only then, can we afford to amuse ourselves with technological and other high falluting theories and why-fors. Personally after 34 years of continued sightings, some close encounters and unexplainable weird UFO related happenings to myself and family; then hundreds of investigations of strangers, acquaintances, even friends whom I interviewed, I do know one aspect for certain. That is our best brains can scientifically prove nothing, for this is a technology and reality that bears no resemblance or relationship to ours, or has the slightest common ground.

The above reports are these which have specifically dated. Many others with only approximate dating have been admitted.

These early reports show a majority of cigar, torpedo or airship shaped objects particularly between 1909 and 1914. Discs, spheres of saucers are only reported in limited numbers. The earliest flight in an airship was by Henri Giffard from Paris in 1852 in a 144 ft long steam powered craft. The first British airship was launched from Crystal Palace on 22nd September 1902, and was 75 feet long. The largest British airship was the infamous R101 which was a colossal 777 feet long and first flew from Cardington, Beds on 14th October 1929. It crashed at Beauvais, France on 5th October 1930. The even larger German craft Zeppelin II was 804 feet in length and its maiden flight was on 14th September 1938. In May and August 1939 this craft made radar spying missions into British air-space

The size of these craft meant they could be seen from long distances and most reported sightings of "air-ships", "cigars" or "torpedoes" seem likely to be actual airships and not "phantoms" as sometimes suggested.



##### (B) Reported Sightings Part 2

1. From E. Dawson-Craven, Christchurch, Dorset.

The object was seen on 25/8/86 at midnight GMT, at Los Boliches, Costa del Sol, Spain, from a penthouse terrace on the sea-front. It was described as a saucer shaped object, a dull orange-red colour like a hazy sun at sunset, and it "waggled" as it turned to follow the coast line.




The object was visible for 5-6 seconds and estimated at a height of 500ft and velocity 1000mph. It was approximately 30-40 feet in diameter and reckoned to be  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile from the witness. Weather conditions were warm and overcast (no stars were seen), therefore misidentification of aircraft or satellites would be considerably reduced.

The illustration shows the movement of the object along the coastline towards Fuengirola and Marbella.

2. From Kevin, Dyfed, South Wales.

The witness related an experience which occurred on 21/1/78 when he was living at Port-Tennent, Swansea. He was staying with his sister during an extended school holiday in Dyfed. This was situated about 15 miles from Camarthen-a small rural village surrounded by hills and moors. To the South-West are the Preseli mountains, which are on Ley-Lines, the witness has since discovered.

On the day of the experience the witness and his brother went to collect milk from his sister-in-laws farm about 500 yards from where he was staying. They were returning with the milk downhill when they noticed a gigantic yellowish white light heading towards them from the left at tremendous speed, making a whizzing noise as it passed them. The object was very low with a trail and it left some scorch marks on a hedge on the right-hand side of the road about 15 feet away.



The object was gone within a few seconds, but a good description was made, it was yellowish white oval shaped, about 50-60 feet from the ground. The time was between 6.30 and 7.00 pm on a cold, cloudy evening.

3. From G.R Stewart, Earls Barton, Northants.

The witness was looking at the stars when he observed a light coming towards him. It hovered for about 2 minutes and then shot off at great speed.

Observations were from the kitchen of witnesses home address. Conditions were described as twilight, with a clear starry sky. The date cannot be recalled, but stated to be "a few years ago."

LETTERS TO THE EDITOR

1. Regarding Timothy Good's letter (Awareness 4 1987-8) - my mistake. I evidently confused the remark by Dr Carr's informat - that "if news of this got out to the whole scientific community, that would be the end of the oil industry" with the comment by Ray Stanford's pseudonymous "Captain Sweeney"

"Captain Sweeney" that public knowledge of UFOs would "blow up the whole economy" (Socorro Saucer, Ch.10). These statements are similar enough to be significant and no doubt reflect an important aspect of the thinking behind the cover-up.

Add to this Gray Barker's reference to a secret meeting at the Hotel Statler in New York in 1953 for "engineers and heads of large industrial concerns". According to Barker's informant, Paul Rear, "the discussions were to centre around utilisation of neutronic energy of a highly advanced nature, and it was hinted that the secret had been learned from taking apart an interplanetary saucer." Rear believed that "this new form of energy would...kill the gas, oil and coal industries.... It was how to make the changeover.... without causing a world economic collapse that the government worried over". (They Knew Too Much About Flying Saucers, Ch.9)

2.

As regards the JFK assassination ("Cover-ups 1988"), the identities of the gunmen and their sponsors are virtually immaterial in the light of indications that both the assassination and the subsequent cover-up were orchestrated from within the Washington establishment.

Colonel Fletcher Prouty, former "Focal point officer" between the Pentagon and the CIA, has reported that security for the Dallas motorcade was highly irregular. An unnecessarily hazardous route was approved by the Secret Service, and specialist Army Intelligence units which routinely reinforced presidential protection operations were ordered not to go to Dallas, despite protests from senior officers (Gallery, Oct. 1975)(Gallery Special Report, July 1979). Standard precautions concerning high buildings overlooking the route were disregarded.

In Best Evidence (Collier-Macmillan 1980), David Lifton presents evidence which indicates that prior to its arrival at Bethesda Hospital in Washington for the official autopsy, the President's body was altered to make it appear that the shots were fired from behind - the area of Oswald's alleged location in the Book Depository - rather than from in front, the source, according to eyewitness and film evidence, of the fatal shot.

Also in Best Evidence Lifton reports the allegation that during the autopsy Commander Humes, the chief autopsy surgeon, was harrassed by Men In Black, who seemed to be trying to dictate his conclusions. Men In Black also cropped up in connexion with accused assassin Lee Harvey Oswald's defection to the USSR (See Legend by Edward Jay Epstein). At one time I took the view that it was MIB of this type - i.e. agents of some hush-hush official organisation - who have bedevilled UFO witnesses from time to time, but I have since modified my opinion.

Dear Mr. Ambler,

I was much interested by your "Cover-ups" article on pages 4 to 9 in AWARENESS, issue 4, 1987-88.

Yes indeed, they are good examples of "Cover-ups", and despite official words of "Love your Neighbour" etc., it seems that human lives are not taken much into consideration, unless governments have very good reasons to avoid panics perhaps?...

Being a naval historian and a contributor to the magazine WARSHIP, I am sending you some information about the 1944 American troop disaster, in case you, or readers could be interested.

Before relating the event I have to point out that German motor torpedo boats were responsible for the attack, not submarines, and the landing craft were escorted by a corvette. In addition there was a distant cover of destroyers, Task Force 27.

It happened on the night of 27th/28th April 1944, when an American group of landing craft comprising 8 LSTs (Landing Ship Tank of 1625 ton displacement each), who were proceeding towards the Devon coast to take part in an invasion rehearsal under the escort of the corvette HMS AZALEA, was attacked by a group of German motor torpedo boats which comprised S100, S130, S136, S138, S140, S142, S143, S145 and S150 who had sailed from Cherbourg.

The action took place in Lyme Bay and, without loss to themselves, they torpedoed and sunk LST 507 and LST 531, while LST 289 was heavily damaged. The TF27 was deployed, with the destroyer HMS ONSLOW who was the leader, but it missed the German MTBs.

The code name for that ill-fated American operation was "TIGER" and the loss of life was heavy: a total of 749 Americans died.

The destroyer HMS SALADIN who should have been with the LST convoy had suffered damage in a collision and had gone into Plymouth for inspection. By an error she was not sailed again to rejoin the convoy, as she could have been, nor was a replacement sent. The result was that only one corvette was with the convoy when it was attacked.

I agree with you that disaster was not well known, only by people dealing with the war at sea.

In fact a US divisional history mentioned the "incident" as far back as 1948, but it has attracted widespread attention only in 1984, probably because of the 40th anniversary of the D-day landings and the big intervention of media to deal with it and everything in connection with it.

Sorry for straying from the UFO subject, I'll try to be more interesting next time!

 UFC REPORTS

14.10.88 West of England, Courtesy of Derek Mansell

11.30 p.m. Windy but clear, Seaton Cornwall.  
A strange light, about the same size as a street lamp was seen. Flashing on and off, keeping the same timing at all times. It was above the trees and looked very low. The witness watched through binoculars for 1½ hours, then gave up. Light was not a planet and far larger than Venus at its brightest. Witness: Mr. D. Mansell.

14.10.88 10.35 p.m. Good Weather conditions. 60 miles from Cyprus. An object was seen from an airliner on route from England to Cyprus. The Captain and crew saw a very large elongated bright green object, go right across their course, climbing at tremendous speed, far faster than fighter aircraft, a speed of many thousands of m.p.h. The report was made by the captain, who lives in Cornwall. The name of the Captain and Airline cannot be disclosed but the aircraft was a modified DC9.

20.06.88 4.30 p.m. Clear and Sunny. Downderry, Cornwall.  
An elderly couple watched through 7 x 50 binoculars, at a square shaped object over the sea and on the horizon. It was very low and a darkish colour and moving down channel to the west, just above the waves, at about 50-60 m.p.h. The witnesses are always watching craft at sea, as their house is on the cliffs. They are positive it was not a helicopter, nor any aircraft known to them. They reported it to the coastguards. Witnesses:- Mr and Mrs Taylor.

June-July 1987 about midnight. Weather? Trerulefott, Cornwall.  
A man was filling his car with Petrol at a service station on the A38 main road when a very large silent shape, swooped low over the garage, heading north. Quite a few people saw this object and were quite shaken. It was supposedly reported to the police and the local newspapers, but no accounts have been found. Witness. Mr. Taylor (not related to above) a Liskeard Garage owner.

2.11.88 9.20 o.m. Very Starry and Clear. Seaton Cornwall.  
I took my dog for its usual run at the back of my property, which is situated at the bottom of a 600-700ft hill, a very rough and lonely area. Suddenly a beam of light came down from the top of the hill. Then this beam flashed upward and kept rotating around the hill. I went up there but could not see any source. I had a powerful torch with me which has a mile long beam, and flashed the light on and off in response. It was visible about 10 minutes. The weather was bitterly cold and I cannot see why anyone should be on top of the hill. There are no animals there. The light was more powerful than mine even though my light is one of the most powerful available, used by fishermen at sea. I saw no tracks at the top in daylight. Witness: D. Mansell.

1960's. Lake District.  
A new colleague of mine was night fishing for carp in the Lake district when a huge shape displaying three large white lights, flew low over him. The only noise was a wooshing sound and he was quite shaken by the ordeal. It happened in May or June. Witness Mr Jinks:

10.1.89 Approx. 12 p.m. Cornwall.  
A motorist was travelling of the Tregantle-Downderry cliff road when he sighted an object in the sky and pulled over to a nearby layby to observe its movements for about 5 minutes. The object was a silver grey, flat-bottomed and dome topped UFO remaining stationary for some time over St. Germans sky space. Unable to stay any longer because of work requirements, the witness set off towards Downderry, but

continually checked the objects position as it slowly moved across the sky. The object disappeared behind cloud directly over Down-derry and no further sighting was made.

The witness observed an airliner flying above the object whilst in the lay-by and approximately 20 minutes later a helicopter flew across the horizon. The object was distinctly different from both of these. Witness: G. Irvine. c/o Sherbro Garage.

MYSTERY FIREBALL OVER OXFORDSHIRE Part Two

In part one of this article, we described witnesses reports so far received. Since then we have been hard at work, tracing witnesses interviewing them, and obtaining reports.

THIS WITNESS REQUESTED ANONYMITY

He was driving home from work Monday 21st November 1988 at approx. 5.15 p.m. north along the Stratton Audley/Stoke Lyne Road, He described his sighting as:-

"I saw this white ball shape fly across the sky for two to three seconds then disappear" The colour was white.

Three other people in the car declined to file a report.

ROBERT WILLIAM MOSS

He was driving home from work on Monday 21st November 1988 at approx. 5.15 p.m. north along the B4095 between Chesteron and Kirtlington. He described his sighting as:-

"I noticed a very bright green light high in the sky to my right. (Possibly to the North) it fell very quickly towards the ground (like a shooting star) but died out, some distance from the ground.

THIS WITNESS REQUESTED ANONYMITY

He described his sighting as:-

"I had just arrived home (Stoke Lyne) on Monday 21st November 1988 at 5.15 p.m. A ball shaped object moved diagonally downwards from left to right for approx. 20 seconds then disappeared. The ball seemed to be a light source with a light tail (The colour was white)

THIS WITNESS REQUESTED ANONYMITY

His description as follows:-

Whilst travelling home 21st November at approx 9.45 p.m. I saw an object travelling at great speed. The object was green and had a rear yellow tail trailing behind it. At the time I was looking up because I was adjusting my rear view mirror. I was travelling between Crawley (Nr. Witney) and Charlbury/Witney Road.

ERIC JAMES PRIOR

He described his sighting as:-

"On the 5th December 1988 at 5.15 p.m. when I got to Gateways Car Park, I noticed a bright object in the sky. The tail was like a flash of light and the front a ball shape. Then it just faded out. The colour was gleaming white.

Conclusion: Regarding the initial reports, made by Mr. Nicholas and Mr. Churchill on the 14th November 1988 - although the objects were sighted on the same day and the descriptions very similar, the time difference is substantial. Mr Nicholas's sighting was reported at 6 p.m. a time difference of 17 hours. Could it be that both witnesses saw the same object or is more than one object

involved? It seems highly unlikely that unidentified objects can fly around our air space, near military air fields without intervention by military aircraft, for this length of time.

The reports made on the 21st November 1988 are again very similar to each other and to the reports made by Mr Nicholas and Mr. Churchill (ball shaped with tail) but the similarity ends there. The discrepancy in the reported colours is very obvious, ranging from green yellow white orange blue and red. It has been proved that no two people see the same thing i.e. people who witness accidents, or robberies seldom report seeing the same thing. Let us consider the possibility that it was one object reported by the witnesses, passing through different layers of the atmosphere causing colour variations to the witnesses, observing from different locations and angles. Here we must also consider the defects in the witnesses eyesight. Colour perception varies considerably from person to person. We are no experts on the condition of colour blindness, (But if any member can enlighten us on this condition, we would be very grateful.) Maybe the question should be added to our report forms, "Are you colour blind?" This may throw some light on the colour variations reported.

Five of the witnesses were travelling by car on four different roads. When checking a map we noted the four roads run almost parallel. The reports from the individual witnesses in Bicester and Stoke Lyne substantiate the descriptions reported by the five motorists. Again the obvious discrepancy is the time the object/s were sighted. They range from 4.30 pm to 6.00 pm. Cont'd .....

Post Script

We reported a sighting by a young lady amateur astronomer in Vol.15 No.3 Page 19-20. The object was seen through a telescope from an observation point in Kensington, London W on January 5th 1988. The witness a Miss Sfeir, described the object as a flat saucer shape, grey green with pink blobs; looking like a "swimming jellyfish". A number of policemen had the opportunity to see the object viewed and were quite astounded. Some correspondence was passed to Contact Headquarters from a lady who wrote to the police witnesses. From these letters it appears that the Inspector present considered the object to be something unusual but did so mention that Patrick Moore had declared it to be a misidentification of Jupiter.

The young lady witness was seen by a number of Data Research members on the TV News and appeared very well educated and lucid. We also stated that:- "We cannot convey how an amateur astronomer could confuse this formation for a UFO - even an absolute novice".

However, since our report on this case which was taken from second hand information, we now understand that BUFORA investigator Mike Wootten was quickly present on the scene, and he reported that the witness had only just bought the telescope - a cheap one to boot - and was a complete novice. She did not appreciate that a cheap lens distorted point sources into blurred shapes and was pointing straight at a bright planet.

The media blew this story up way above its true station, mainly because the witness sounded (and maybe looked) good and several policemen were not prepared to stick their necks out and declare

the sighting to be a planet.

This shows how easy a deception can be created - unless BUFORA was wrong!

OBITUARY - Walter Raymond Drake

Raymond Drake held a season ticket for Sunderland (United Football Club) for many years. He died at the match at Roker, not far from his home, 1st April 1989 aged 76. (Born 2nd Jan 1913). A career Civil Servant, he eventually became head HM Customs & Excise in Sunderland.

Raymond was known to ufologists for his "Gods and Spacemen" books, the first of which GODS OR SPACEMEN? was published by the 'grand-daddy' of flying saucers' Ray Palmer in Amherst, Wisconsin in 1964. Authors such as Desmond Leslie, George Hunt Williamson and Brinsley Le Poer Trench, preceded him, and Erich von Daniken's CHARIOTS OF THE GODS came later in the UK in 1969. In fact Erich and Raymond were well acquainted and he was an honoured speaker at the 2nd Ancient Astronaut Conference in Zurich in 1975 and at subsequent events. No doubt von Daniken's phenomenal success helped Raymond's work gain in popularity. In pursuit of his research he studied about twelve languages and it may be no coincidence that he was more popular abroad than at home. He found several publishers in Brazil, France, India, Italy, Japan, Spain and the USA. Several UK paperbacks were published by Sphere.

Perhaps his style of writing did not endear him to everyone and here is a snippet from BUFORA JOURNAL March 1980:

"We descend not from ape-men, but from glorious Celestials from the stars. Today we use only a fraction of our potential brain-power. My friends, we are more than men, we are the Sons of the Gods'."

Raymond's writing included plays, science fiction novels and poetry, much of which went unpublished or was only privately circulated. A twenty verse whimsical SF poem "The Stolen Bride" appeared in SPACE-LINK magazine \*Vol 5 Nos 2 & 3. Raymond & I were amongst contributors to a glossy book, BEYOND THIS HORIZON, An Anthology of Science Fiction and Science Fact, published in conjunction with the BTH Festival in 1973 where we appeared on the platform together at the Sunderland Arts Centre.

Raymond's struggle to find publishers was an example to all despairing authors. Where readers had difficulty with foreign exchange he often had no hesitation in mailing off gratis copies of his books and he will be missed by his many worldwide correspondents. He was married for forty-five years and leaves a widow to whom we extend our sympathy.

The "Soviet Union"

The changing political outlook in this vast country indicates that we in the West will be learning new facts about cover-ups going back to 1917 the year of the Russian Revolution. There must have been so many important happenings in these years that we must treat the whole country as one massive cover-up. Why such natural disasters as earthquakes, floods or hurricanes were never fully reported to western news sources is really quite amazing. On the other hand, the appalling purges of Stalin's day would obviously be covered up.

Recent programmes on television and in the press indicate that the supposed Soviet threat from missile attacks in the late 1950s and early 1960s was, for the most part, an exercise in tub-thumping by the then leader, Khrushchev. At the time Khrushchev made his famous belligerent speech to the United Nations, it is now reckoned that the Russians could launch only 4 missiles against the USA. Huge displays of military hardware seen in the Mayday and Revolution Day rallies in Moscow were reckoned to have been sent round in a circuit and passed the rostrum in Red Square 3 or 4 times to give the impression of huge depth in arms.

The recent earthquake disaster in Armenia resulted in thousands of badly built tenement flats collapsing like packs of cards. Some reports indicate that architects and builders were well informed of the earthquake dangers of this region, and of the need to reinforce buildings against such eventualities. However, they chose to ignore the facts and built cheap specification buildings with disastrous consequences.

The last Czar, Nicholas the 2nd, and his family were allegedly shot to death in their place of exile in 1918. The full story of these events is just coming to light with publication of facts first discovered in official archives in 1979, but suppressed under the old administration.

Further unveiling of cover-ups next time perhaps .....

The Great Electro-Magnetic Field "Cover-Up"

It cannot be established whether there is a case to answer or even if the authorities are covering up startling facts relating to the harmful effects of electromagnetic fields. In the past year three separate and alarming situations have come to light. These may or may not be inter-related.

(1) The investigative television programme the Cook Report visited homes in southern England where electrical appliances, T.V sets, light bulbs etc had all blown repeatedly indicating huge surges in electric voltage. The cases in question were isolated and no rational explanation could be found - except the proximity of these homes to secret defence establishments.


(2) A link between cancers and proximity to electrical power-lines has been investigated. A higher than expected number of people contracted cancers of the worst kind, who lived directly beneath power cables or in very close proximity. Some cases investigated were people only in their thirties or forties.

The authorities deny any danger from these sources, but there can be no doubt that electro-magnetic waves are passing through the body

in the vicinity of power lines. This can easily be demonstrated from interference picked up on car radios when passing under a power-line. Somebody living directly within this field could be subjected to a breakdown in body cells over a long period of time. At the moment there is only circumstantial evidence, and builders continue to erect a large number of houses underneath these ugly structures. A vast estate is under construction at Didcot, Oxon directly beneath huge cables and only a mile from a major generating station.

(3) A large number of cot deaths of young babies occurred in January and February 1989, ten within seven miles of the top secret Royal Aircraft Establishment at Farnborough, Hants. Five of these deaths occurred on one night said to be the coldest of the Winter at the time. Whether this implied that the babies had not been kept warm enough, is thought to be highly unlikely, as this area of Surrey is extremely wealthy and nearly all homes would be centrally heated and double-glazed.

A remarkable explanation of these events has been put forward and published in the Sunday Mirror. Researchers believe electro-magnetic waves generated from airport radars, trains and electricity pylons and mystery pulses from secret defence establishments combine to somehow "fuse" a baby's brain and kill it. Scientific tests carried out by investigator Roger Coghill showed that a huge pulse of electro-magnetism could be detected over the cots of several of the babies who had died. This pulse was not present in other parts of the homes examined. It indicates that at certain places "hot-spots" of electro-magnetic energy may be found, and it is very unfortunate that babies' cots may have been situated on these points. The diagram below indicates a possible situation whereby a "hot-spot is generated.



It seems somewhat frightening that no government funds have been made available to investigate these very suspicious events. The ever increasing range of electronic equipment being used commercially now adds to the hazards already present from electricity power-lines, airport radar and other utilities. Does someone know the facts about these monsters of modern technology? Of course the country would grind to a standstill if we closed down airports, power stations and the like.




