




## EDITORIAL

Yes its happened again! A UFO passed right over the top of my house while I was having dinner. The time was 6:30 pm on January 19th. Within 10 minutes my next door neighbour came down from the farm track where she was walking her dogs and announced with absolute authority that she had witnessed her first UFO after 60+ years of disbelief. Now my neighbour is a tall, no-nonsense figure of respectability in the village here, and she had a perfect view of what went across being in total darkness on rising ground. Of course there was no chance of my seeing it - the object had skimmed across the sky within 5-10 seconds. It sounded like it could be a shooting star - absolutely not she retorted - it was in level flight as low as 500 feet and blue with a long tail. In fact it was so low it needed to hug the contours of the ground like a cruise missile! We are looking into the last possibility, but it was totally silent as well.

Having guests present and an imminent theatre visit. I was unable to take this further, but on returning home I heard that the same object had been spotted in the Oxford, Didcot and Reading areas by at least 6 other independent witnesses. We now know that this UFO was heading North-South and 3 more witnesses picked it up over Hampshire. Almost all said the time was 6:35pm. Remarkably other people not on this route reported a similar object at the same time. Does this imply a mass display of separate UFOs?

Another witness in the Oxford area witnessed a similar green UFO the following Tuesday, January 24th, and was so overwhelmed by the experience, inspite of his advanced years, that he drove straight to the nearest police station to place a report.

There is no doubt that something very potent is moving around and inducing strange reactions in those that witness it. The similarities to the March 31st 1993 UFOs, the "hottest" night for many years, look to be overwhelming, and individual reports of the blue object with a long tail have come up on file many times in the past year.

Further work has been undertaken by Data Research members in photography by flash across dark fields. This augments the project undertaken by the Plymouth UFO Group and reported in the last edition of Awareness. Even without a definite target spot we have produced some photos that are literally mind blowing! Four or five of these show structured manifestations which are entirely invisible to the naked eye. Nobody can explain them, but are we deluding ourselves? Take a look at the photocopied reprints following inside. If you think this is crap, we need to know. If the camera does not lie than we may be interacting with an entirely new life concept.

Are you aware that much UFO material is coming through on the Computer Information Highway or "Internet"? Our Roswell USAF report was obtained in this way. It is also possible to send out enquiries concerning sightings, and an answer could come from anywhere on the network. The overall result may be a much greater understanding of some of the bigger UFO events.

I am reminded that we are getting far too cheap! The subscription rate has not increased for at least 5 years and similar magazines are almost double the subs charged for Awareness pro rata. The printers will want more for this first 1995 edition - so please £9 for 4 or £14 for 8 next time round.

Some disappointing news to end on. Our specialist contact at the Ministry of Defence, Nick Pope, has been moved on. After 3 years of openness and great co-operation from the M.O.D. it appears that fundamentalists are back in place. A reply to a detailed letter I sent recently gives



### "THE FIRE RETURNS"

Latest Sightings overview by Data Research

The overall picture from the first 2 months of 1995 is of considerable activity in parts of the country. The strongest sighting was of a blue tailed object on January 19th. We have now about 10 direct or indirect inputs about this very powerful light which flashed across the south-central area of England at 6:35 pm. It was definitely moving rapidly and silently past Oxford, Didcot, Reading and down to Hampshire on a north-south trajectory. The speed was colossal as it was gone within 5-10 seconds from all observation. Most witnesses reported it extremely low even following the contours of the ground as it moved. This presupposes it could have been



something like a cruise missile, but enquiries to the M.O.D. have failed to elucidate an answer. The only other explanation would be a shooting star or meteorite, but no witness gave the slightest indication about this - confirming the object was in steady horizontal flight. One of our reports indicated there might be a smaller second object moving in convoy with the main component. The last impression was similar to many witnesses' testimony on March 31st 1993, except the speed was much slower on that occasion.

A further 3 or 4 reports came from areas of the country not in direct line with the main January 19th sighting. These included Luton Airport, St Asaph (North Wales), and Yiewsley Middx. Once again the times were almost identical at 6.35 pm, so could there have been several objects darting about in a co-ordinated display?

What can move through the atmosphere at the speed of sound or greater and make no noise whatsoever? There is no sound in a vacuum (space), but where there is atmosphere, the flow of air against solid objects creates it. From the above descriptions we would expect enormous booms and screaming sounds from an aircraft as low as the witnesses reported. The noise from engines even if the object were slow moving would be most noticeable. Helicopters below 500 feet are quite deafening and even the notorious Virgin Light Ship emits a faint humming. It can only be concluded that the total silence reported indicates that the object is not disturbing air and cannot be solid unless totally new concepts of propulsion are being operated.

Data Research have several cases to hand of incredibly powerful "flashes" of energy reported many times in 1994 and right up to date. The most significant have been picked up in the Gloucestershire area and observers on watch near Avebury, Wilts, last Summer on the many projects being undertaken associated with crop circles - also reported them.

It is assumed that the flashes cannot be lightning as many have been reported very early in the morning when lightning is uncommon outside forecast storms. The effect must be quite startling for witnesses to log reports on a phenomenon only lasting a fraction of a second. The whole skyline is lit up according to some versions.

We are still receiving accounts of purported triangular shaped objects festooned with lights over the Eastern side of England. These sightings are of hovering or stationary objects. The latest comes from Arnold, Notts at 8.10 pm on February 21st 1995; the object was in view for 20 minutes. Also reports from Bonnybridge in Scotland continue to reach us.

Some spectacular displaying UFOs appear to be operating in the Bristol/Bath area. Videos of an object moving around over the Bristol Channel in December has been forwarded. The movement approximated to that of a dirigible but enquiries indicate none of the usual culprits were mobile in that area.

A wonderful exhibition of fluorescent blue objects dividing, making trails of light with multi sparkles, and veering between saucer and jelly-fish shapes was reported from Bath just before midnight on March 2nd and lasting until 00:50 on March 3rd.

A witness produced a very artistic rendering of what was seen. We cannot rule out some sort of laser show for this one, but it was on the very bleak, snowy night of March 2-3 and very late for such activities to be taking place.

Once again we have been plagued with misidentifications of the Virgin Lightship and one or two other similar blimps as they trundle home from special shows usually at the weekends. We know that the base for a number of these craft is at White Waltham near Maidenhead, Berks so analysis of the direction taken by any reported object might give clues to its identity. There is an outstanding case from 28th December of a craft manoeuvring near Kidlington, Oxford which sounds as if it might be the lightship, but behaving in a very odd manner with no sound. The direction of flight reported does not agree with a known movement of a lightship returning to White Waltham from the Midlands out around the time reported.

## FURTHER VIEWS ON "ROSWELL"

### PUTTING THE LUNATICS IN CHARGE

#### A dissenting view of the Roswell Case

Those who believe that the shortest route to mental health is to put the lunatics in charge of the asylum will be reassured by the findings of the recent USAF investigation of the Roswell incident. More realistic observers will ask whether, on a continuing issue of national security, the USAF would admit that alien vehicles ever penetrated USAF airspace, or would ever accuse senior officers of lying to the public about it over a period of 50 years. There is, as Geoff Ambler points out in his article The First Real UFO, a significant analogy between the way the American authorities have handled the UFO phenomenon and the way the British authorities handled the V2 menace during the last war. So long as there was no solution to the V2 problem, the V2 explosions continued to be explained away as the results of leaky gas mains and Nazi sabotage squads. As soon as the allied troops had overrun their launching sites, the cloak of deception was allowed to fall away and Joe Public learned the truth about these ghastly weapons. However, NATO has yet to overrun the UFOs launching pads, so the deception continues.

Those with some knowledge of how these things work will know how hard it is to penetrate a determined cover-up and get at the unvarnished truth. Two cases in point are the Kennedy autopsy material and the Shingle Street legend. In both cases so much disinformation has been fed into the record that the shape of the truth being concealed remains blurred in outline, even when obvious lies have been identified and eliminated.

The Shingle Street case is of particular interest. The legend is that, during the last war, a German seaborne invasion was thwarted in a horrific manner when gallons of petroleum were pumped into the sea off the Sussex coast and ignited. According to an alternative version, the victims were an allied task force, tragically blown off course and misidentified. Officially the story is pure myth, but derives from two uncontested facts:

1. Petroleum being one of the things we had in abundance, urgent research was carried out to see if it could be used as a weapon of war.
2. British Intelligence systematically spread rumours in occupied Europe, particularly among apprehensive German troops in the Channel ports, that an invading German force had already sustained hideous injuries as a result of the British setting the sea on fire. Officially these rumours were pure propaganda, part of the "bodyguard of lies" of which Churchill boasted.

However, James Hayward and other researchers have encountered witnesses with convincing stories of charred bodies and even of mass burials. No documentation whatever has come to light to support these claims, which remain unproven but cannot be dismissed out of hand.

Wherever it is possible to check the details and methods of the 'extensive' recent USAF investigation of the Roswell case, 'cries of "whitewash" and "cover-up"' seem amply justified.

Consider the section beginning, 'The article (in the Roswell Daily Record, July 9th, 1947) further related that Brazel thought that the material: "might have been as large as a table top."'

The alleged quotation from Brazel, the farmer who first reported the wreckage, proceeds for a further three hundred words, supplying information which Brazel could hardly have been able to supply at first hand: "At least one paper fin had been glued on to some of the tinfoil... There was no sign of any metal in the area which might have used as an engine." One might further wonder why, if Brazel immediately recognised such mundane materials as rubber, tinfoil, Scotch tape, glue and paper, he thought the wreckage worth reporting at all, let alone suspected that it came from a flying disc. We have seen from other accounts that, by the time he spoke to the Daily Record, Brazel had been thoroughly intimidated by Air Force Intelligence, and it seems fairly clear that the Daily Record was simply asking Brazel to corroborate an official description of the wreckage supplied by the Air Force.

In a derisory three-line paragraph, Major Marcel, who, years later still talked of his sense of wonder at the Roswell wreckage, and Colonel Blanchard, Commanding Officer at Roswell Army Air Force Base, are rubbished on the preposterous grounds that they did not know what the term "flying disc" really meant, even though the press had been talking of little else since Kenneth Arnold's sighting of June 24th, 1947.

We should remember that Colonel Blanchard put his career on the line by ordering the issuing of an official press release on July 8th stating unequivocally that a flying disc had been recovered. If he really did not know what the term meant, his recklessness beggars belief.

If I had any doubts about the reality of the UFO crash, the tone and style of the excerpts from this USAF report published in Awareness do much to allay them. It is not an impartial report but a propaganda exercise designed to belittle and ridicule.

I see no reason to doubt the integrity and essential accuracy of the Blanchard-Haut press release. It was issued in haste, evidently to avoid the curtain of secrecy which Blanchard knew would inevitably descend. We should respect Colonel Blanchard's courage, quick thinking and sense of public responsibility.

It may be Colonel Blanchard's haste which accounts for one curious anomaly which must be acknowledged. Both the Blanchard-Haut release and an earlier alleged first hand report by newsman Johnny McBoyle refer to "the rancher" (Brazel, presumably) putting the disc under cover. McBoyle is alleged to have claimed: "I've seen it... Some rancher has hauled it under a cattle shelter with his tractor," and the Blanchard-Haut release states: "The rancher stored the disc." Most Roswell believers now maintain there was an explosion aboard a UFO which scattered debris on the Brazel ranch, but that the damaged hull with its humanoid occupants landed many miles distant. Be that as it may, the Blanchard-Haut release remains a vital touchstone, and it is up to the debunkers to suggest what possible motive underlay it, apart from a straightforward way of reporting the truth.

### ROSWELL - THE MISSING EVIDENCE?

Editor: A very interesting document dating from 1968 has come to light - being a comprehensive study of the UFO phenomena in the USA by a senior physicist of the time. It was presented in a symposium to the House of Representatives committee on Science and Astronautics.

Out of 41 detailed cases there is no mention of Roswell at all - the USAF report suggested it was not recognised until 1978. However it is clear that in the first ten days of July 1947, significant UFO activity was being reported in the western states not far from the purported crash site. In fact as many as 85 UFO reports were published in press accounts for July 4th 1947. The Roswell event looks to have taken place between July 2nd and 7th.

The following 4 cases were selected by the author James E. McDonald. Do they prove anything or not? The author appears positive on UFOs throughout.

It could be that what with the Arnold, Mt Rainier sighting on June 24, 1947 plus all the activity in early July, somebody may have jumped to too many conclusions with reference to the reports in the Roswell press on July 8/9 dug out much later on. There is no mention of any "alien" beings in the original 1947 data researched by McDonald. A major cover-up might also explain the missing case history.

Boise, Idaho, July 4, 1947.

Only about a week after the now famous Mt. Rainier sighting by private pilot Kenneth Arnold, a United Air Lines DC-3 crew sighted two separate formations of wingless discs, shortly after takeoff from Boise. I located and interviewed the pilot, Capt. Emil J. Smith, now with United's New York office. He confirmed the reliability of previously published accounts. United Flight 105 had left Boise at 9:04 pm. About eight minutes out, en route to Seattle, roughly over Emmett, Idaho, Co-pilot Stevens, who spotted the first of two groups of objects, turned on his landing lights under the initial impression the objects were aircraft. but, studying them against the twilight sky, Smith and Stevens soon realized that neither wings nor tails were visible on the five objects ahead. After calling a stewardess, in order to get a third confirming witness, they watched the formation a bit longer, called Ontario, Oregon CAA to try to get ground-confirmation, and then saw the formation spurt ahead and disappear at high speed off to the West.

Smith emphasized to me that there were no cloud phenomena to confuse them here and that they observed these objects long enough to be quite certain that they were no conventional aircraft. They appeared "flat on the bottom, round on top" he told me, and he added that there seemed to be perceptible "roughness" of some sort on top, though he could not refine that description. Almost immediately after they lost sight of the first five, a second formation of four (three in line and a fourth off to the side) moved in ahead of their position, again travelling westward but at a higher altitude than the DC-3's 8000 feet. These passed quickly out of sight to the west at speeds which they felt were far beyond then-known speeds. Smith emphasized that they were never certain of sizes and distances, but they had the general impression that these disc-like craft were appreciably larger than ordinary aircraft. Smith emphasized that he

7 had not taken seriously the previous week's news accounts that coined the since-persistent term, "flying saucer." But, after seeing this total of nine unconventional, high-speed wingless craft on the evening of 4/7/47, he became more interested in the matter. Never-the-less, in talking with me, he stressed he would not speculate on their real nature or origin. I have spoken with United Air Lines personnel who have known Smith for years and vouch for his complete reliability.

Portland, Oregon, July 4, 1947

In the course of cross-checking a sampling of the 1947 cases that went into Bloecher's study, the numerous daytime sightings in central Portland on 4/7/47 seem worth checking, especially because many of the reports come from police and harbour patrolmen. Here again, we deal with a case for which there are so many relevant details available that space precludes an adequate summary. I spoke with Sheriff's deputy Fred Krives who, along with several other deputies, had seen some of the many objects over Portland from the Court House across the Columbia River in Vancouver, Wash. Krives recalled that over half a dozen deputies were outside looking at what they estimated to be about 20 disc-shaped objects in several sub-groups racing across the sky at an estimated height of perhaps 1000 ft., heading to the southwest.

Both from contemporary press accounts and my own checks, it became evident that more than one formation of discs flew over Portland that day. Harbour Patrol Capt. K. A. Prehn, whom I located by telephone, told me that he had been called outside by another officer who spotted objects moving overhead towards the south. Their speed seemed comparable to that of aircraft, their outlines were quite sharp, and they looked metallic as they flashed in the sun. They occasionally wobbled, and their path seemed to be slightly irregular. Other officers with whom I spoke sighted discs from other parts of the Portland area; one of them, Officer Walter Lissy, emphasized that he recalled them as zig-zagging along at "terrific speed." Another officer, Earl Patterson, told me of seeing a single object that "made sudden 90-degree turns with no difficulty." I also obtained letter accounts from others in the Portland area who saw disc-like objects that day. Here was an early instance of unidentified objects manoeuvring in full daylight over a major city.

Fort Sumner, New Mexico, July 10th 1947.

A mid-day sighting by a University of New Mexico meteoriticist, Dr. Lincoln La Paz, and members of his family was summarised by LIFE magazine years ago without identifying La Paz's name. Bloecher gives more details and notes that this is officially an Unidentified. At 4.47 p.m. MST on 10/7/47, four members of the La Paz family nearly simultaneously noted "a curious bright object almost motionless" low on the western horizon, near a cloud bank. The object was described as ellipsoidal, whitish, and having sharply-outlined edges. It wobbled a bit as it hovered stationary just above the horizon, then moved upwards, passed behind clouds and re-emerged farther north in a time interval which La Paz estimated to be so short as to call for speeds in excess of conventional aircraft speeds. It passed in front of dark clouds and seemed self-luminous by contrast. It finally disappeared amongst the clouds. La Paz estimated it to be perhaps 20 miles away, judging from the clouds involved; and he put its length at perhaps 100-200 ft.

Harborside, Maine, July 3, 1947

An observation by an amateur astronomer, John F. Cole, reported to official investigative offices near the beginning of the period of general public awareness of the UFO problem, involves an erratically manoeuvring cluster of about 10 objects, seen near 2.30 p.m EDT on 3/7/47 on the eastern shore of Penobscot Bay. Hearing a roar overhead, Cole looked up to see the objects

milling about like a moving swarm of bees as they travelled north-westward at a seemingly high speed, as nearly as he could judge size and distance. The objects were light-coloured, and no wings could be discerned on most, although two appeared to have some sort of darker projections somewhat resembling wings. In 10-15 seconds they passed out of sight.

### ROSWELL - AIR FORCE DIS-INFORMATION ?

For the past decade, I have been an avid reader and collector of the Roswell Incident and the mystery of the cover-up surrounding it. The wealth of material and witnesses that have come to the fore since 1947 have utterly convinced me that there is no smoke without fire! But how does one go about sorting the wood from the tress?

During my collection I have obtained the usual videos, books and reports written by various authors and even to a mortician's report of an alien lain in the vaults wrapped up under the secrecy of the US government. Could all this have been a mistake? Have I been fooled along with countless others that Roswell was definitely a 'non-starter'.

Recently I was handed a complete 24 page USAF Report on Roswell, to wit. Congressman Steven Schiff had formerly instructed the General Accounting Office (GAO) to look into "Records Management Procedures Dealing With Weather Balloons, known Aircraft, and similar Crash Incidents". This investigation, although unstated, is mainly to look into the Roswell Incident and see if the US Army Air Force did in fact pick up a crashed Saucer and perpetrate a 'Cover-Up'.

The GAO notified both the Air Force and other governmental agencies that it would comply with Schiff's request and the Air Force decided to do its own investigation before the GAO's findings had been concluded and released.

The document compiled by Richard L. Weaver, Col. USAF Director, Security and Special Program oversight, firstly summarises the famous Roswell Incident - a crashed saucer with debris scattered over a wide area on Mac Brazel's ranch, Nr Roswell, New Mexico. The Army Air Force(AAF) dismisses the whole incident and claims that the debris was from a crashed weather balloon from a secret programme, one known as Project Mogul. The whole thing had been hyped up by person/persons both in ufology or otherwise claiming an 'event' took place.

Project Mogul's purpose was to detect Soviet nuclear tests by using specialised sensitive instrumentation carried aloft by high altitude balloons and being the cold war period, there was serious concern by the US that the Soviets might develop an atomic weapon device.

Be that as it may the AAF certainly went rummaging through their archives to show that a thorough investigation had been carried out and that no stone was un-turned. They investigated written material or rather scanned through the works by William Moore, Charles Berlitz, Kevin Randle and Donald Schmitt, George M. Ebbart, Stanton T. Friedman etc., but side-stepped any issues or witness reports that would confirm that something more than a weather balloon had crashed. It certainly did not refute any claims but excused comment by saying that it was hearsay or the facts had been taken out of context etc.

Under the heading WHAT THE ROSWELL INCIDENT WAS NOT - it was concluded it was not:

1. An Aeroplane Crash - as none were reported on or near the date in question.
2. A Missile Crash - though White Sands Missile Base was a testing base.

3. A Nuclear Accident - The 509th Bomb Group was the only military unit in the World at that time that had access to nuclear weapons, and there was no recorded accident within the Department of Energy files.

4. An Extra-terrestrial Craft - Surprisingly there was absolutely no indication that what happened at Roswell involved an extra-terrestrial spacecraft.

Although in section 4 the point was raised that was actually recorded in the Historical Report for the 509th Bomb Group and Roswell AAF and that stated:

"The Office of Public Information was quite busy during the month answering enquiries on the 'flying disc' which was reported to be in possession of the 509th Bomb Group. the object turned out to be a radar tracking balloon."

There apparently was no indication of heightened activity of military personnel that would point to an 'event' or notices of alerts regarding 'Alien' craft on US territory and considering everything was always meticulously recorded in their paperwork in duplicate etc. It is unlikely that something as major as this would have gone unrecorded.

WHAT THE ROSWELL INCIDENT WAS - was neatly packaged in absolute detail of how the debris was a conventional weather balloon made up of foil sticks and plastic. There were a good few affidavits thrown in for good measure which endorsed the case. The load was gathered and transported from Roswell Army Air Field to Fort Worth by military personnel with subsequent statements from AAF employees who either saw, felt and carried the material at some point during its eventual evacuation.

Interestingly a Major Irving Newton (ret) was located and interviewed and according to the report he was at the time ordered to report to General Ramey's Office to view the material. In a signed sworn statement Newton related he had walked into the General's office where he saw this 'supposed' flying saucer that was lying on the floor. As soon as he saw it he giggled and asked if THAT was the flying saucer... he confirmed it was a balloon and a Rawin Target attached. Newton also stated that "MAJOR Marcel tried to convince me that the notation on the sticks were alien writings but I was unconvinced." According to Berlitz and Moore's book, 'The Roswell Incident', Newton was ordered into General Ramey's Office but he was briefed by a Colonel to the effect that an object had been found by a Major in Roswell and the general had decided that it was really a weather balloon and wanted him (Newton) to identify it as such. He claimed that parts he was shown were definitely parts of the balloon, and that he (Newton) had sent thousands of them up! He was then dismissed back to his duties.

Certainly throughout the report the AAF appears to have taken seriously the field of debris - although there is no indication that evidence of non-human remains was ever pursued. Their conclusion was quite evident that they did not locate or develop any information that indicated a UFO event. Their official line is that - the wreckage recovered from the Brazel Ranch was from one of the Project Mogul Balloon trains and that the project was TOP SECRET at the time. There was no specific indication that an official pre-planned cover story was in place at the time and that the events that took place actually did happen.

The final paragraph deals with their full co-operation with the GAO and have supplied all requests for assistance and helped with any queries that have arisen. It is stated that the report was generated as an official response to the GAO's request.

Finally - "It is recommended that this document service as the final Air Force report related to the Roswell matter, both for the GAO or other enquiries. "

Well I suppose for ufology this is no more than could have been expected. I suppose the main

## CATTLE MUTILATIONS IN NORTH WALES

Cattle mutilations seems to be a subject that passes the credulity level of most English researchers. They throw up their hands, or raise their eyebrows at 'those Americans'. But why? This is belittling the enormous efforts of Linda Moulton-Howe and her professional colleagues, such as veterinary doctors and forensic scientists, who have given up many years to careful analysis and study of these cattle mutilations right across all the counties of the U.S.A. Why this tendency to decry all things American in UFO research? Can it be envy that they seem to have far more money to put towards it, when the British struggle along on a shoestring?

In fact cattle mutilations go on not only in America but Devon, Cornwall and Yorkshire, and for all we know in most other countries of the world. Our English tabloids keep the public very ill-informed as to what goes on in the rest of the world, except of course which famous or infamous figure is hopping into bed with whom!

I can only report, I cannot say that aliens did this, but it seems logical to suppose that as they genetically engineer us human-beings, which even English ufologists are beginning to have to accept, the evidence is coming more and more to light. Then it is logical to suppose aliens are also experimenting upon our animals on this earth.... even British ones!

On Sunday the 9th October '94 night a farmer by Penryn Bay, Clwyd had the heads of two of his pregnant sheep cut off, also the fore legs cut off and all disappeared. The back legs were broken, but there was not a drop of blood anywhere.

One week later, either on Sunday the 16th October, or the early hours of Monday morning a farmer at Llandrillo further into the countryside had five of his sheep, Scottish Blackfaces, have their bellies slit open, and a neat hole to the heads; again no blood.

Was it a coincidence that from late August into September of this year, we had 14 crop circles up to the Cheshire border? the harvest was gathered very late this year, so the circles remained some weeks, yet in so far as I know, only a small band of Ufologists took an interest in them. Absolutely no-body mentioned them, nor did the Press take the slightest interest in the North Wales ones. So if they were hoaxed, the effect created must have been a disappointment to the hoaxers. Add to this the flap of UFO reports we have had here. I am only a single individual, people in our rural areas, who are conservative, have got, respect and trust me, so I get a lot of reports by recommendation. this is something I have had to earn and work hard for. I still realise from the 2nd hand accounts I've been getting from May onwards almost daily, that I have only scratched the surface of the sum total of sightings in North Wales this year. At the time of writing I have heard that a huge orange ball was seen over Denbigh Hospital yet again, and that someone in the Wrexham area was recently abducted.

I have been contacting an interested person in the local police and to date nothing about the cattle mutilations have come to light, and it appears even they consider them mysterious. As do Joan Amos, Douglas Cooper and George Spurgeon who were consulted, and they know far more about the subject that I do. The first two are UFO researchers of many years standing in Devon and Cornwall. Mr Spurgeon is an abductee, who has since taken a particular interest in animal mutilations, and researched this subject quite a bit.

Editor: Data Research have an interest in seeing some of these mutilations, but pestering farmers might not be too productive. How quickly is the evidence removed? Who actually gets to see the bodies other than the police or vets? Can anybody suggest how we might institute some practical research? Trawling the country at 4 in the morning might be one answer, but not likely to be very successful.

Any link between UFOs, crop circles and cattle mutilations is open to question. Circles are available for all to see and indicate a non aggressive or destructive intention, all stems being unbroken. Could the same source produce unspeakable mutilations in animals? The question of ritual abuse is cloaked in mystery - just how many practitioners are there? Children claiming satanic abuse were shown to be deluded from recent cases in Orkney and North East England. The dark side of human mind is the problem in coming to any definite conclusions in these subjects.

## ILLUSIONS - OR PHOTOGRAPHS OF DESTINY

Some details of staggering images seen on flash photography shots were released in the previous edition of Awareness. The project undertaken by Plymouth UFO Group lasted from August 16th to October 21st 1994. At a meeting held at Glastonbury on October 11th it was agreed that Contact Int. would undertake to replicate the Plymouth pictures at various sites in the Oxford area. This would show whether there is an overall phenomenon or the anomalies seen are due to properties of cameras, films or atmospheric effects. In the event both Brian James and Geoff Ambler working with their own equipment and locations have now produced some totally different and inexplicable images. Although quite a lot of film has been wasted, it has been well worth the effort as about 6 photographs show literally mind boggling features which have never been recorded before to our knowledge. The best shots illustrated opposite may arise from camera trickery, but certainly not from weather conditions. We appeal for advice from any reader who may be able to assist in the analysis. Here follows a synopsis of the various accounts and some of the background that lead to these experiments. In view of our current lack of understanding of what is seen, technical details of films and cameras have been omitted.

**Previous observations:** Plymouth UFO Group first recorded "lights" appearing in crop circle photographs from the 1991 season. These 5 daylight shots were reported in Awareness Vol19 No3.

Pictures taken in August 1992 by Nancy Talbot(USA) on a visit to Avebury showed milky white spheres around standing stones, John Sayer took a picture of Silbury Hill from the car park on 30th Dec 1993 which revealed something like 2 dozen anomalous spheres in shot. (1)

There is a lady in Georgia, USA, who apparently attracts unknown globes of energy to her. In a night picture shown in the Connorsville News-Examiner of Oct 29, 1993, a very large globe is seen plus many smaller less bright surrounding the figure of "Mary Ann" who is known as a UFO witness/abductee. Over there the features have been entitled "Tesla Globes".

Many other occasional instances of light globes appearing on photos are being reported regularly. these occur on daylight shots or in the dark with flash.

**The Terms of Reference:** The amount of time the shutter opens and/or flash operates is of order 1/100 - 1/1000 second for most modern cameras. For human eyes 12 frames a second is the limit on moving film before "persistence of vision" occurs. The old fashioned jerky motion is seen at this speed, but at modern speeds of 25 frames a second an even movement is obtained. We now know that a rogue frame containing a non-relevant image (subliminal) can be inserted as a single frame into the sequence of film and will influence the human mind for advertising or more sinister purposes. Nobody can see the image unless the film is freeze-framed but it effects the subconscious mind somehow.

Thus an "event" could take place within 1/25 second, that our eyes are incapable of interpreting. However, on fast films, the "event" can be captured. The ultimate conclusion is that a separate World of rapid moving non-physical life forms co-exist around us. Have they always existed or is this a new concept? Much remains to be done before we can say for certain.

A number of geometrical shapes on the photographs have been seen on TV films of outdoor events particularly where flood lights are on, so there is obviously a question of deciding which images are induced by the camera and which are "paranormal".

**Plymouth Group Photographs:** The field where 1991 films were taken showing images on 5 shots has been continuously monitored. When unexplained "Dragonsfeet" appeared in the wheat field next to the one mentioned, during August 1994, it was decided to undertake a serious study taking pictures across this area. A photograph with a ball of light had been taken on August 5th about a mile away, which finally gave impetus to the project.

The following is a synopsis of Plymouth Group visits to the field:

10/8/94 Overcast conditions, 48 shots taken; no lights on any; cattle disturbed.

19/8/94 Overcast conditions, 48 shots taken; aware of "sparkles" over the crop with naked eye; double ball of light on one shot over cattle herd; eyes of cattle shown for comparison; Time 9pm.

21/8/94 Overcast afternoon. no photographs showed lights. Odd markings in wheat crop newly arrived.

24/8/94 Overcast conditions, 60 shots taken - 6 with light effects. Strange bird noises noted. Aware that visible effects were prominent just after sunset so future shots were to be taken in "gloaming" period.

27/8/94 Clear conditions. No lights on 48 photos, although usual visual impressions obtained. Cattle restless.

30/8/94 Overcast, occasional light rain. 18 light photographs out of 48 taken. Sparkles seen in flash. Square lights appear for first time, but only on one camera. Remainder 2 cameras show round lights. Some squares had corners cut off. Many other strange features on some shots.

1/9/94 Clear sky. No light photos on 48 taken, but twinkling noticeable to naked eye.

6/9/94 Clear sky. No light photos on 48 taken. Again although group felt that features were present nothing showing on film. Decided results only achieved in overcast conditions.

15/9/94 Stormy, strong winds and rain; 18 out of 48 photos show lights. First appearance of hexagon and diamond shapes. Beautiful blue light on single shot.

20/9/94 Overcast, clear over fields. No lights on 72 taken. Impressed by brilliant moon. Usual visual effects present.


23/9/94 Torrential rain - 48 lights on 48 photos (100%). With 2 cameras - half round shots, half square shots.

29/9/94 Overcast. 4 lights out of 84 shots although conditions were deemed to be perfect it did not work to plan. "Cosmic Joker" at work? Appeared to be some response for "asking" lights to appear.




Picture 1 The "Face"

rapid sequence taken at 19:50.

18/10/94 Heavy overcast, gale force wind, dry cold. 48 lights on 48 photos. Suspicion that some were not paranormal, but on one film FACES appeared on third last shot.  
21/10/94 Torrential rain. 48 lights on 48 photos. Sparkles seen in flash; photograph of sparkles taken across flash showing lights of different shapes and densities. Group felt completely deflated - did moisture effects explain everything? at the end of the project - Bob's views (with Martin's and Marc's) as follows:

"And the questions !!! Here are only some.....

- \* Why, when there must have been millions of flash photos taken in overcast conditions, had lights never been reported before ?
- \* What are the dots ?
- \* The face ???
- \* In torrential rain, why are all the photos not totally obscured by lights? Why do some shots in rain have no lights, when those before and after, do ?
- \* Why do the dense white lights always appear to be moving upwards ?
- \* On the squares, how are corners cut off ? On some shots different corners on different lights.

After finding the cause of the majority of the lights, we collapsed !! We ended with over 200 light photos. And though would have preferred a paranormal explanation (of course), felt we'd done a thorough investigation into a new 'phenomena' and were pleased with its successful completion - and delighted with the extraordinary, and unique, photos obtained.

However, when it came to writing the report, the problem was that all that had happened could be written off as imagination, damaging our credibility as investigators. But as investigators, we have to record what happened. And the fact is that all we had seen, the 'sparks in the stubble', flying lights, winking lights, the 'bats' and 'butterflies', were seen; they were not our imagination. Four of us saw them, and they were seen by 2 or more people, on every visit to the fields. And similar lights have been reported at other places.

We look upon ourselves as 'hard' investigators. We are only interested in hard facts. If the paranormal, the mystical is to be revealed, then there is no room for if's or maybe's. One of our working rules is - if in doubt, leave it out. We know the lights and other phenomena seen in the fields were seen, and not imagined. There was paranormal phenomena going on all during this investigation.

It can be said we were fools not to 'solve' the lights earlier, but that is when only the photos are considered. For us, the photos were only part of the 'magic' 8 weeks of investigation. From the beginning it seemed as if we were being led step by step into this. From the first 'cow's eyes', then the lights over the cows, then a couple of shots of small lights, then more, then square lights, then more and more and more - then the Face.

Endeavouring to photograph a known light phenomena, corn circle lights, we, for the first time ever, photograph lights that have never been photographed before. It is understandable that we thought the lights were the ones we were after.

This account only gives some of my own main 'sightings'. Martin and Marc also saw many things which may be included in a later report. We all felt the investigation was notable experience."

Contact International - Geoff Ambler: Geoff has taken 7 lots of photographs with 2 different cameras. where to take them was the main problem - and he attempted to find a location by

map dowsing. A field at the end of Garsington village near Oxford came through. On the very first try on November 8th 1994, a partly used film of 10 shots produced 2 inexplicable pictures on the 6th and 8th. The first of these shows a big red glow at the top of the shot and the second a spiralling object completely covering the photograph (see illustration). No replication of this spiral has been achieved since then. Nothing visible was seen at location.

Later efforts have proved disappointing with an occasional fuzzy white globe appearing but not to the extent as on some of the Plymouth photographs. Location variations have not added further to the effects. A visit to the Rollright Stones circle produced nothing even though strange energies are known to exist around such features.

Contact International - Brian James : Brian has concentrated on establishing which effects can be put down to atmospheric conditions and which may be paranormal. Using slave assisted flash many of the Plymouth effects have turned up at various locations on shots taken over the Winter months, although it should be said none of the really opaque blue balls taken at Plymouth have surfaced. Pictures of rain and snow taken in the dark with flash have been processed.

It was not until February 4, 1995, that Brian suddenly achieved an unbelievable break through when 3 shots taken locally at Blewbury produced something "out of this World". On two of them a structured entity of great beauty is apparent and sits cheekily behind the hedge probably less than 30 feet away from the camera. On the second shot the object is fully focused (see illustrations). This is reminiscent of Ed Walters Gulf Breeze UFO which may be the only warning note to sound. There is still much to decide about these pictures so further details will follow.

As with Plymouth researchers, there is evidence of the "COSMIC JOKER" at work. After 2 months of dubious results, Brian is about to conclude his work when the most fantastic manifestation comes through - as if to say "don't give up on it". At Plymouth as soon as very strong results were achieved the following sessions proved insignificant or leading to believe the effects were not paranormal. Geoff got an early break through and since then very little else on his cameras. Its all a big tease at the moment. We suspect there must be an awful lot to come, but for the moment.....

## THE CASE FOR SUBTERRANEAN FACILITIES

by M.C. Soper

There always has been since the advent of the systematic study of UFO (Flying Saucer) Phenomenon, the persistent rumour that there exist either underground or subterranean bases which are frequented by non-human intelligences.

In history the world 'cobalt' which comes from the German 'Kubold' meaning the 'goblin of the mines' which had a blue or grey complexion; in fact reputed to have a hue similar to the blue of Oxon's county town. There is even the myth that the blue was chosen by the ancient institution because the origin of the hue was known to have this association, and knowledge is power. Whichever way this comment is viewed, the association with underground places and Agharti with non-human intelligences is a constant and repetitive feature that is very difficult to explain away; since the miners must have agreed on the hue.

Thus we arrive at the quirky-seeming idea of 'saucer-bases' which, given the acknowledgement of the existence of UFOs have quite a strong case : La Razon (Buenos Aires): '...the true explanations of these occurrences can(not) be kept secret much longer...' ...yet another northern paper: 'the arrival of this interplanetary craft on(to) an aerodrome in the province of Corrientes ...a fact that can(not in any way) be disputed, given the manner of its appearance and the calibre of the eyewitnesses... serves to strengthen the view that there may be Space People's bases somewhere in the country, in view of the great number of recent sightings...' (our stress). More Buenos Aires papers carried this account in August 1962: 'Senor Vincente A Bordoli from Mar del Plata, a driver, was driving along Highway number three on a regular run when on more than one occasion he had seen with his son numerous luminous craft both climbing out of the sea and diving into the sea, apparently controlled by signals coming from the sea. He concluded his statement: '...absolutely certain(ly) ..in the depths of the Gulf of San Matias there is a flying saucer base...'

There are other reports that there is a UFO base which is underwater in Lake Titicaca. This belief in underwater intelligent denizens is not entirely far fetched when the human anatomy is considered, with the many obvious adaptations to aquatic life (skin, frogfeet, spatulate palms, wide shoulders for swimming, and head hair coded by colour).

More disturbing have been the recent accounts from Mexico and the North of South America that deer hunters, who traditionally wait in trees overnight for their prey to appear have far too often than is expected died from old age (or microwave possibly); the number of such cases and the similarity is really most remarkable; and the implications of this seem to relate to one specific fact by a force or forces unknown. Deer hunters who lie in wait in trees are often very roughly treated. There has been a very strong rumour that there is a UFO base on Puerto Rico, and the evidence which can be brought together is rather impressive:

- 1) 31/5/87 a huge underground explosion occurred.
- 2) 1/6/87 10.00pm local time many witnesses saw a huge UFO over Cartagena.
- 3) 30/5/87 red ball of fire seen moving over Laguna Cartagena (2 am).
- 4) Mrs Ramirex de Perez claims her entire family since 1956 have seen UFOs there.
- 5) on 1/6/87 a green military unmarked helicopter landed on Sierra/Bermeja hills.
- 6) Witnesses saw military with geiger counters at this spot.
- 7) 100 witnesses saw two US navy fighters abducted in mid air by a huge triangular UFO which then disappeared (28/12/88).
- 8) Then many military planes constantly crossed Laguna.
- 9) Five apparently alien creatures were seen in Cabo Rojo.
- 10) A fisherman in a boat saw more denizens in La Pitahaya (July 1989)
- 11) Mrs Marisol Camacho saw two small aliens in her garden(13/8/91 Cartagena).
- 12) A disc and two more came back one fortnight later.
- 13) End August in same area another alien was seen by motorcyclist in a swamp.
- 14) May 1991 a 90 year old encountered five denizens of standard small type in same place.
- 15) Numerous sightings like 14) occurred near a Cartagena radar facility.
- 16) When this facility was being built in 1989 a guard met some of the creatures.
- 17) Carlo Maule Mercado described their base during contact.

We will give details of his complete account later. However for the moment so many consistent accounts fit together as collected by Jorge Martin (UFO Update; Timothy Good) that there is a very sound case for saying either there is a type of UFO base nearby, or a 'thinness' to a next dimension, or a gigantic psychological experiment is being run in this area by some authority with vast resources. Is there any point in the absence of the cold war, in psychological experiments of this type, nowadays?

The account of Carlos Manuel Mercado: 'I was trying to get some sleep that night, ...so hot that I simply couldn't... my family was asleep. I got up and lay down on the sofa in the living room, trying to get some sleep there, ...suddenly I saw a flash of light outside and heard a buzzing sound. A few moments later, someone knocked three times on the Venetian Blinds... I got up and opened the window, and there they were... three small men looking (towards) me ...they weren't human ..I was shocked,... a voice told me (mentally) ...DO NOT BE SCARED, EVERYTHING IS FINE. NOTHING IS GOING TO HAPPEN TO YOU. DO NOT BE SCARED. WE WANT TO SHOW YOU SOMETHING...

"I was shocked ...when I heard the voice I felt very calm. They asked me ...come out...not with their mouths. They never opened their mouths, this was ...in mind. So I opened the door. I felt I had to... somehow I knew they wouldn't harm me...

"Two of them took me (holding hands) to the front of (the house\_ (opposite the Sierra Bermeja) and down the road... I couldn't believe (this) ...there was a flying saucer there ...standing on three metallic legs ...round, with a dome on top, and windows, and many coloured lights round the rim ...there was an opening in the underside, a hatch, from which a long stairway came down to the ground ...they asked me (now) to climb up the stair and board the craft... there were more of those little men inside, and the place was full of machines with many coloured lights and panels. This was in the area of the windows ...like a flight deck in a dome ...the little men introduced me (then) to a taller being who was about my size (5 feet nine inches). I felt more comfortable with this one because, even though he was like the others, he was taller and looked a little more human-like. He was dressed in a white robe, and they said he was their captain-medic.

This taller being explained they did not mean to harm me; that they only wanted to show and tell me something so I could later relate (this) to other people. He said something to the others at the panels and I felt the landing legs coming up, and a clamping sound ...the hatch closed and the craft began moving. I was impressed ...not afraid ...they kept me calm somehow. The craft shot up, and I believed we would go far away ...instead (the craft) seemed to veer to the left and descended towards the Sierra Bermeja. I was afraid we would crash, ...a hole appeared in a depression to the side of El Cayul mountain and the craft went all the way down ... through a tunnel and came out in a big place that seemed like a long large cavern.

There were many barrack-like structures or buildings inside the place, and hundreds of little aliens working... as though on production lines, assembling electronic, mechanical parts or machinery. There were many craft down there ...not like aeroplanes or helicopters; they were saucer-shaped, or triangular or hexagonal-shaped.

Then the tall being said: "As you can see, we have a base here for the maintenance of our crafts' systems. We have been here for a very long time and don't intend to leave... We want the Earth people to know that we mean no harm, that we don't mean to conquer you either ...we want to reach out to you and establish a direct relationship which will be beneficial to both parties. Earth people can rest assured that we don't mean harm in any way."

I said, "Why me.. I'm a simple man, and no one will believe me."  
He replied: "(This) doesn't matter ...people will hear you as well as many others we are contacting and bringing here to show them the same. When people with knowledge hear what you simple people... as you call yourself ...are saying, they will know that you are telling the truth..."

After that they brought me home, and before leaving told me that they would be back someday. At first I was afraid to talk about this ...when this thing with the jets happened, I worried.

Maybe this has something (related to) the beings down there, and I know... I felt ...that they are good, and harmless. Knowing this I decided to talk... to you ...and let you know what happened."

The description given by Manuel : the small beings were four feet tall with big pear shaped heads, pale grey skin and big black slanted eyes with no pupils. They had no ears, a small slit for a mouth and merely two orifices where a nose should be.

Their outline was roughly humanoid, with longer arms in proportion; hands and heads only were outside their suits which were one piece and sandy-coloured. They seemed to have occasional zits on their skin.

These odd little details seem to indicate that these small beings are either not perfectly adapted to the Earth environment which affects their skin or alternatively they continually take dietary supplements to deposit a layer of protein contiguous with the surface of the skin which contains metal. This might be done to protect the workers from the work they do ; after all this principle is not unknown to our workers to need to wear protective clothing against some radiations. Another culture would take metallo-organics to achieve the same purpose. For example the continual taking of silver-protein, a very bitter substance to humans, would result in a subcutaneous layer of silver which would be disfiguring though most useful for workers who had to handle hot radioactive materials constantly. Personally I believe the skin coloration is due to subcutaneous metal, though not to guard against radioactive rays. The purpose is more subtle.

The following places in Britain have been associated with the concept of UFO bases: reservoirs in Waltham Forest and Lea Valley and also Stack Rocks off the South West Welsh coast has been associated with numerous sightings of craft diving straight through the rock face apparently. North West Wales also has such a connection with the idea of a local base. when the augmenting effect of increasing local population density is subtracted from the report density in Great Britain, then the two main areas have larger than expected numbers of reports, South West Wales near the Coast, and North West Wales also near the coast. True there are in the areas indefatigable investigators; however there are also indefatigable investigators in many other areas of Britain who work steadily for years without receiving any dramatic or interesting reports at all (all reports being of the 'nocturnal lights' category).

Pauline Coombes from Ripperston in 1978 reported that she saw an Unidentified Flying Object flying towards Stack Rocks off the South Welsh Coast, near Haverford West and claimed that as the craft dived towards the rocks, a door opened in the face of the rock to admit the craft. This was at the climax of a whole series of baffling events surrounding the Coombes family (as detailed in THE UNINVITED by Clive Harold, Star, 1979).

Now one rather odd feature of these 'UFO base' reports is that they nearly always involve a body of water, and somebody nearby is always either shown or told that there is such a base. Now suppose there were truly some kind of inter-dimensional base nearby the best way to ensure that the base did stay a secret from the general population is telling of one individual of unusually perceptive character, after they had been made half crazed by a series of odd events, some of which are true and some of which are false. Choose an extraverted character who is sure to keep on phoning the police and the press, until the press no longer completely believes; then show them the base, and show only that single individual. Then when in the future somebody else sees the base, they also will not be believed because among other things a precedent has been made for not believing in that 'UFO base' rumour.

There is evidence that this 'cover-up' by dismissible disclosure technique has recently started to

fail in the United States of America. This has resulted in the recent obsessional interest in Abductions ; which of course is entirely justified by the nature of the phenomenon itself. We may legitimately ask why the British media have taken up the abductions scene to some extent, though not always with total seriousness. Whereas the 40000+ cattle mutilations, some of which have occurred in Britain produce scarcely any interest at all. 40000 cattle mutilated by laser scalpel dating from 1973 in Colorado and Arkansas ; the corpses exsanguinated to a completeness and extent which is unbelievable, tripod marks founds at the sites (and also at the 1980 CEIII at Rendlesham in Britain) and small humanoids which walk awkwardly and enter oval shaped craft also seen at the sites by reliable witnesses.

The question of why the Abduction scene with slightly less good evidence should have gripped the papers whereas the eminently provable account of the animal mutilations (mutilated by a process beyond current human technology) as publicised by Linda Moulton Howe Productions (Strange Harvest), is largely neglected latterly.

Here is one account of a UFO-base experience by Mrs Coombes (excerpt from THE UNINVITED, Clive Harold, Star - concerning the Welsh 1977 experiences) : 'Tina saw (the object) first pointing frantically upwards in the direction of the object and screaming at everyone to look at what was happening ...Pauline looked quickly over her shoulder, a sense of panic seizing her again ...the object had started to move, climbing slowly now, drifting higher in the sky as they watched ...not revolving as its shape seemed to require ...holding its position and just rising gently, in a perfectly vertical ascent. Tina was motionless, seemingly struck dumb by the sight ...her head back and her mouth gaping in amazement ...and still the object rose higher in the sky above them ...rose maybe another fifty feet, until... about two hundred feet up, stopped momentarily and then, with frightening suddenness, shot off towards the cliff-edge, then plunged down towards the outcrop of rocks, beyond the cliffs ...and was gone.

'Pauline found herself wince, Tina turned her head away ...and she could see her parents duck down in the rear seat of the car in anticipation of the explosion they all felt would surely follow... there was nothing. Everything was still ...somewhere a bird trilled in the hedgerow ..as though nothing had happened... for what seemed like an eternity, they all ...stared blankly in the direction of the cliff-edge, towards Stack Rocks and the horizon of sea beyond, neither speaking nor registering any emotion.'

Now this was a disappearance witnessed by a whole family, this event was also witnessed by Pauline Coombes' friend Rosa who called up from the Haven Fort hotel where she was staying: "Look I had to call you to let you know what I've seen ...unbelievable really ..I couldn't believe my eyes. I was looking out across St Brides bay through my binoculars ...like I sometimes do ...when I saw this silver, disc-like object come skimming over the fields ...below your farm and then ...dipped down and went into Stack rocks. ...Went into them, Pauline, like ...I don't know, like a door had opened in the rocks ...you'll probably think I'm crazy, love, ...that's exactly what (appeared to happen). And that wasn't all ... the more I kept looking at the rocks, the stranger ...shortly afterwards I saw these silvery figures walking about over there, coming down from a sort of door that kept opening and shutting and then walking to the water's edge and then back again... incredible, I know ...that's what I saw, Pauline, honestly..."

The Dunfermline Press for the tenth of June 1994 includes an account by two witnesses of some unidentified flying object plunging into the River Forth; this happened in 1989, and also in 1990 a silver disc hovered over the Forth Bridge for some time (according to Jaques Vallee 'Challenge to Science, Spearman' - cases where discs hover over metal bridges are quite common).

Thus an explained vehicle interference case and a photograph of a hovering craft in the same spot by a man who was setting up for an artistic exhibition in May 1994(?) when taken together

with the other evidence does seem to suggest that a subaquatic base in the Firth of Forth is a possible claim; note that when a person comes forward not being familiar with the UFO scene and UFO claims and states that craft were seen to fly into the side of a hill in which a door appeared to open; then we have a good case since the witness has no vested interest or expectation that there should be such a phenomenon; hence an hallucination, or hoax is not likely to contain this extremely improbable seeming piece of information.

Basic information concerning the nature of the facilities is lacking; though historically there is a surprising large body of lore concerning underground beings and their ways; the use of word by the ancient Britons, Britons may have been an attempt to disguise themselves as the Kubolds, thus deterring would-be attackers. Is the situation now reversed: is American military hiding the usage of Alien technologies inside Stealth devices and high-tech. planes?

### REVIEW

#### SURVEYING THE LIMITS OF THE THINKABLE: ALAN WATT'S UFO QUEST COMPENDIUM.

The subtitle of this book by Alan Watts: 'In search of the mystery machines', and this is what this readable and thought provoking book actually does.

This book moves from New Age thought to the early days of the 'Flying Saucers' and on through antimatter, radiation beams, Corn Circles, to mind-benders and Puharich who was much involved with the Council of Nine. This survey is interestingly constructed and leads to many thoughts, and just before I begin this review a lady rang up and told me that she had spent many years in mediumistic activity concerned with determining facts about the World, and was surprised to find latterly that many of these messages seemed to emerge from those associated with UFOs and were channelling to her. She found herself associated with beings like the Council of Nine, Ashtar Command, Aura Raines, Romilar, Monka, Solarstar and the Etherian; and much to her surprise much of the material about the physical nature of the World was evidently UFO based rather than spiritual, which was the way she had started off once. Now Alan Watts starts his quest with theories of flying craft displacing the air and is forced slowly by the evidence itself to investigate other types of model which is where sound, radiations, harmonics, the great pyramid, and the reception of enlightenment from elsewhere all come in. Now the difficulty is that while scientific orthodoxy says that hyperspace and hyperdrive MIGHT exist (under rather special circumstances), UFOlogists know that something like this MUST exist already to account for UFO disappearances and faster than sound silent 'travel' in the atmosphere with colour changes, any many other effects. In a sense we must already be within higher dimensions though with our pathetic single method of detection and sensation (an incomplete process; acknowledged) called the photon this higher space, which can be inferred (in the physical sense) from the complete evidence (electrical rotations exist, Klein-Kaluza), so that we actually are in a space of higher dimensionality and see Plato's shadows on the wall of the cave cast at different angles occasionally.

The essential reason for becoming involved in the SECOND STAGE of UFOlogy called channelling is that the channelled messages can give us a second view of the World compared with the photon (sight, sound, heat, touch, smell) a kind of stereo view of the World whereas before we had all been peeping through a keyhole.

Watts suggests or infers that 'molography' (solidograms) may cause crop circles, in order to communicate with us, a type of electromagnetic brush being used for this purpose. The strength of this book is that at least he did have a go, tackling the daunting task of coming up

with an explanation with zeal and knowledgeability. Note that 'armchair' UFOlogists who are not industrious in checking the old data and the new patterns in the corn are really and genuinely missing out on a chance to absorb a truly new view of the World and nature whilst this is revealed now.

Even next year there may not be the chance; we cannot predict how long the crop circle communiques will continue in future years locally. The book 'The Only Planet Of Choice' outlines the **views of the Council of nine** and what they expect for us. This book by Palden Jenkins is all about channelling, whereas the book by Alan Watts is more concerned with communication and explanation.

The book UFO QUEST (in search of the mystery machines) published by Blandford press ISBN 0-7137-2449-8 Cassell 1994 LONDON for £7.99 :for an economical survey this book is just about right.

#### WITHOUT CONSENT: By Carl Nagaitis & Philip Mantle Published RingPull Press 204 Pages £16.99.

This book represents the first ever comprehensive look into British only abduction cases. We know that there are enough tonnes of American material to fill a library - so is this collection of 25 or so events over the U.K. more representative of the true situation worldwide? Like fundamentalists quoting the Bible do we accept lock, stop & barrel what happened was exactly as stated, being a physical experience, or is it something far more profound involving levels of consciousness we can only scratch the surface with? Do equal numbers of abductions take place in France, Germany or Italy, for instance, being countries of similar population to Britain? Or is the whole business an American wonder like coca-cola?

Pushing 25 cases into 200 pages gives less than 8 pages for each of them allowing for comments from the authors, so the reader does not get too intimately involved with any one case as in Whitley Streiber's Communion say. Are we here for titillation or hard facts, based on genuine investigative work? Knowing Philip Mantle for many years, it is likely to be the latter, but unfortunately titillation makes bucks in today's market.

I write this review having had a good part in investigating the "David Thomas" case in North Wales 1985. This occupies pages 30-37. When I wrote up the events in Awareness in a factual way as reported to Contact Int., I was amazed to find the report reproduced in journals all over the World over the next 8 years. Young "Thomas" certainly had a tale to tell, but frankly there was nothing tangible that I witnessed which could verify anything he said at the time. There was the waterlogged field where the spaceship stood; impossible to walk up to it from the road. The probe marks on his wrists were not significant to convince me. Why then did he get his worried mother to drive him down to Oxford on a freezing February night in order to express himself to Contact International. Yes something must have happened to him but what?

The same goes for most of the other cases. Are there really great scars on bodies where probes have gone inside? Where are the famous implants that purportedly reside in nostrils of victims? I have never seen any. It has the same scenario as religious manifestations, depending on the faith in question. In the end it breaks down to anecdotal evidence and what you want to believe.

Nearly all the cases reviewed by Mantle and Nagaitis exhibit the "missing time" phenomena. that seems to be the key to what is going on. In the missing 20 minutes or longer the abductee

is subjected to what I would consider a "psychic implant" which alters the balance of the mind. Some witnesses see a brilliant light or UFO before this happens. Afterwards recall is very variable - a few remembering almost everything; others only snippets, but can be regressed by hypnosis. In the aftermath some like "David Thomas" request absolutely no publicity, but others like Elsie Oakensen or Lynda Jones like to tell the World.

"Without Consent" is important reading for the genuine UFO researcher. If it answered the cause of abduction without a shadow of a doubt then it might score more heavily. But like this review, it poses more questions than answers.


### A DOSSIER OF GREEK UFOLOGY

*The following reports from Greece and Cyprus, not published before in the U.K., have been kindly provided by the Unidentified Phenomena Investigations Team, of Thessaloniki (UPIT). We are indebted to investigator Omiros Karajas for translating the material. The sightings have been summarized by Brian P James.*

**12:Mar:1916 - Thessaloniki:** A 'Zeppelin' appeared over the city, and caused an electrical power failure. French army gun batteries fired at the mystery 'airship'.

**1925 - Mt. Ymittos, Athens:** On the night of the noon before the International Rising of the Holy Cross - a significant religious festival - over 2000 people were indulging in a night vigil at the monastery on Mt. Ymittos. At midnight, a strong white cross came across the sky from East to West, its brightness obliterated the stars, and illuminated the ground all around the monastery. This was seen by all of the people there as a sign from God, and all of them, including soldiers, fell to their knees in worship. After 30 minutes, the cross disappeared.


*\* It is interesting to see how such an event was described and explained in earlier times, particularly in a religious environment, as it was considered to be a miraculous vision. \**



**Aug:1929 - Kriki, Chalkidiki:** On a Sunday night at about midnight, Moustakas Theocharis, a farmer, was traveling in his truck from a flour mill. The sky was clear, and suddenly Mr. Theocharis saw an object like a parachute above the road. Below the object, 3 small beings were observed, and the witness was able to hear them talking in what to him was an alien language. The beings had white skin, and were dressed all in white, with hoods covering their heads. For some reason the beings repeatedly jumped over a fence at the roadside. Mr. Theocharis observed the object and beings for 20 minutes, before he ran back to the village, and told other people when he reached the village square. Some villagers proclaimed he was crazy and was seeing devils, but others confirmed that they too had seen these beings on many occasions.

*\* A note of interest on this area is given by Omiros Karajas, as it was near Kriki that the bones of Neanderthal man were first found in the Cave of Petralona. \**

**6:Oct:1954 - Vrissa:** The mayor and residents of Vrissa village saw a UFO at 15.15hrs. The witnesses saw a luminous white star-like object, high in the sky, which circled over the village for about 15 minutes. The object departed by flying very quickly to the northwest, then to the north, before finally leaving to the west. This was reported to the police on Lesvos Island by telegram.



**10:Oct:1954 - Stypsi:** A hunter, S. Horiatis, and his 12 year old son were near the village of Stypsi. They saw a luminous cigar-like object that moved across the sky. After a few minutes, the UFO changed to a vertical position, and split into two similar cigar-like objects that then flew in formation. It was reported that these two UFOs were seen by many witnesses in Turkey.

**13:Oct:1954 - Pilion:** Mr. Helios Voghiatzis from St. George village saw a luminous object over Mt. Orthrys at night. The object moved east to west at low speed, and disappeared over the horizon after a few minutes. A report was given to the local police department. Mr. Voghiatzis was a well educated man, and well respected in the local area, and he asserted that it could not have been a meteor.

**17:Oct:1954 - Drama:** On the Sunday morning, a dentist - Miss Athina Gelemiti, and Miss Sophia Kapaoura, saw a UFO above the horizon to the east of Doxaton. It was described as being like a 'tail', and moved in a circle. The colour started as red, but then changed through all colours of the rainbow. The object was observed for 5 minutes before it disappeared over the horizon. Reports of 'flying saucers' were made by many residents of the village of Chorish and the local area.

**19:Oct:1954 - Aghiassos:** The commander of the police of Aghiassos, on Lesvos Island, sent a telegram to the Ministry of the Interior, confirming that a UFO seen over the area 2 days previously has been seen by hundreds of witnesses. It was luminous, circular, and was approximately 2-3 km above the ground. It was visible for about 30 minutes before it disappeared. However, it, or a similar object, reappeared 10 minutes later, which then separated into two objects. These two objects were seen for a few minutes until they disappeared in different directions.

**23:Oct:1954 - Didimotichou:** It was reported that all of the residents of Didimotichou-Orestias were excited, after many people who had been grazing sheep saw two cigar-shaped objects appear from the sky. The objects landed for about 20 seconds before disappearing very fast.

**27:Oct:1954 - Rhodes:** During the night, a huge luminous disk was seen circling over the city for about 5 minutes. The object approached a balloon used by the radio station *Voice of America*, and then disappeared at high speed. The object was seen by people at the *Acropolis* hotel, and later by many other witnesses, including police officers.

**30:Oct:1954 - Kos:** A sighting over Antimachia, of an object like 'a big basket', flying at high speed and emitting bright light, seen by Miss Erine Sarri and Mr. Socrates Karaliamis. The object changed direction before disappearing. A curious, possibly connected event involved another villager at about the same time that night. Mr. George Kakamoundis saw a human-like creature with wings. The humanoid flew over the head of the witness before disappearing quickly. Mr. Kakamoundis fled the scene to seek sanctuary in the nearby church, where he stayed for many hours.

*\* One is immediately reminded of the 'Mothman' creature investigated by John A. Keel. \**

**05:Apr:1955 - Argalasti:** A 56 year old farmer, Mr. Thrasivoulos Mouslis, decided to go out to his meadow after 11.00 hrs at night, to check on his animals in the cold weather. The witness suddenly noted a strange light towards Lacouli. It was described as being like a circular, red 'burning net', apparently burning from one end to the other, and it was described as being bigger than the sun. The object appeared to be on the ground, but then it slowly disappeared before rain started.

*\*This sighting occurred 10 days before the big earthquake of 1955. \**

**31:Jul:1962 - Marathon:** Nicholas Vrettos was walking on the coast at Marathon at 21.55hrs, the beach was crowded with people. A gigantic spherical object suddenly came into view, moving steadily from north to southeast, and at a low altitude, just above the Pendeli mountain range, which peaks at 1,109m. The object was circular from all angles, being like a ball of glowing light. It was orange in colour, with no other lights, or surface features. It was bigger than any conventional aircraft, there was no vapour trail, and there was no sound. The speed was estimated at less than 10kmh, and had already been visible for some 15 minutes. The object then began to move upwards in a parabolic path, it then changed colour to green and accelerated upwards, but still was visible for a further 10 minutes before being lost to sight as its apparent size reduced while it went towards the constellation of Lyra. The witness estimates that the object was just over 7km away from the beach, and must have been at an altitude of about 3.5km. By using a coin the witness estimated that the object's diameter would have been about 300m. The meteorological service of the Greek Defence Department indicated wind speeds of between 8 and 16 kph at the time of the sighting, with a temperature of 25°C, with humidity around 68%, visibility was at least 16km.

*\* An additional note to the sighting was the behaviour of a St. Bernard dog nearby, which barked agitatedly all through the sighting. Two weeks later the dog died without any special reason. \**



**30:Jun:1966 - Athens:** Nicholas Vrettos was serving as a soldier, and was on sentry duty at a camp in the Athens suburb of Holargos. Mr. Vrettos was on duty from 11.00hrs on the 29th, to 02.00hrs on the 30th, and sometime between 00.45hrs and 01.00hrs, the witness observed 3 objects for nearly 30 seconds. The witness was looking northwest, and saw the 3 objects flying northeast to southwest, flying a 'zig-zag' path at a tremendous speed, quite in excess of conventional aircraft, but slower than a meteor, and they were lost to sight below the horizon. All 3 objects were cherry red in colour, they were devoid of noise, and had no discernible vapour trail. The objects were estimated to be about 3.5km away from the witness, and at a height of 3.2km. Five minutes after the first sighting, the witness was still looking at the sky when a new object came from behind the Aegelous range of mountains in the southwest. It was also cherry red, and zig-zagged across the sky to the northwest at tremendous speed, again with no noise or trail, and moving faster than any aircraft, then was lost to sight over the Parnis mountain range after only 4-5 seconds. This object was estimated to be some 15km away, and at a height of 5.5km. Weather conditions were confirmed to have winds from the south between calm and 6kmh, visibility was in excess of 16km.

**Sep(?):1972 - Sappe:** A UFO was seen by army personnel on patrol on their camp, and they returned to camp after their duty period. The UFO was in sight for a total of 2½ hours during a clear, cool night. The witness woke his lieutenant, who observed the object through binoculars, but the shape was difficult to make out. The object moved up and down, and was a bright, circular shape, described as having a 'crystal, silvery brightness', and was self-illuminated. The object sometimes hovered, and sometimes moved around the sky, and at times performed loops. Both men viewed the object through the sights of an M-1 gun, and another lieutenant observed it through binoculars. After an hour, another light appeared, smaller than the first, and it performed similar movements. The first witness had strange, indescribable feelings at times, but mainly he felt the shiver of fear.

*\*Through friends, this sighting was made known to George N. Balanos, the then Greek representative of APRO. \**

**Mar:1973(?) - Attica:** The crew of a Finair Boeing 707 aircraft reported a strange object flying towards their plane. The UFO was seen on radar by controllers at Ellintkou airport, and it later approached the airport terminal itself. It was like an aircraft, but bigger than normal, and moved much faster. The Finair Boeing 707 was flying in from Saudi Arabia when an object was seen ahead on their radar, prompting a red alert when the controllers assumed a collision was imminent, the 707 was given permission to take evasive action if necessary while attempting to descend. Controllers confirmed that there were no known aircraft on the same flight corridor, and military bases also denied they had any aircraft in the area. The UFO sped past the 707, and the following conversation occurred between the controllers and the pilot:

Tower: "What is it?"


Pilot: "A flying object with strange, very bright lights..."

Tower: "What did you see?"

Pilot: "Jesus!... Forget it, guy, there is no problem. At any rate, it was not an airplane."

The Boeing 707 proceeded to land normally, but the pilot was understandably asked again by over 30 air traffic controllers what he had seen, but again only replied "A strange object - it was not an airplane." The same night the pilot of a Kenyan Airways aircraft also saw the UFO. The UFO did not appear on radar as a normal aircraft. It should be noted that at the time, an American aircraft carrier, possibly the *USS Forrestal* was operating in the area.

*\* Those of you who have seen Steven Spielberg's film 'Close Encounters of the Third Kind' will recognise the similarity of this Greek report to scenes in the film. \**



**16:Nov:1973 - Andros Island:** Many students saw a luminous UFO, while walking late at night near the beach at Liopesi. At 23.15hrs the students saw a luminous ellipsoid at an estimated 2000-3000m high. The edges of the ellipsoid were emanating a diffuse, but strong white light that surrounded the object with a ring. At the top and bottom of the disk were small green tails. There was no sound, and the flight was erratic, either hovering, or moving very fast, including looping. This object was visible for 3-4 minutes before being lost to sight behind the 1003m high Mt. Petalou. On its flight the object passed through a cloud, which was strongly illuminated.

**27:Dec:1973 - Sparti:** Many residents of the city saw a luminous UFO hovering over the slope of Mt. Taygetos, at 21.00hrs. The object eventually moved from north to south.




