EDITORIAL"ALL THAT GLITTERS" ARE NOT UFOS!

We reported a multi-witness experience of 15 or more light forms drifting across parts of north London on February 1st, 2007. The jury was out on whether these were UFOs or "Chinese Lanterns". Our chief investigation officer, Bill Foley, produced a very detailed file on all the news and investigation reports of this case and now concludes that it was "Chinese Lanterns" that were seen. In fact the activity has been narrowed down to the release of Lanterns in Waterlow Park, Highgate Hill, close to the location of the sightings. This was a mark of respect to a young Chinese person who had died and Camden council had been informed. Similar reports from Kings Lynn, Norfolk, on February 3rd were sourced to a wedding party held at the town's Riverside restaurant. The restaurant's owner, Mrs Pat Ishill, said: "they were called 'Glow Lanterns' and worked on the same principle as hot air balloons. I have never seen them before. They were quite large - at least two feet tall - and they were very effective." A member of staff who released the Lanterns at the restaurant was not surprised to hear that they were a hot topic of conversation at a Radio Norfolk phone-in the following day.

Many similar reports are emerging such as 50 orange lights which hovered in the sky over Sussex during snow falls in late January, 2007.

We have located several sources of supply for the Lanterns on the Internet. For instance, "Sky Lanterns" suggest their product is just the sort of thing for your wedding celebration and offer "Display Lanterns" at £120 for 20 or smaller "Home Lanterns" at £40 for 15. The company state that their product, also known as "Kung Ming Lanterns", was invented in ancient China during the epoch of the Three Kingdoms as a means of communication during war time. This would be similar to the use of hot air balloons during the siege of Paris in 1870.

Thus what we are seeing has been round for a very long time, but is a complete new concept in Western society. From the original press reports concerning the Islington display, it was stated that: "people screamed and cars came to a halt when dozens of mysterious lights hovered over Archway this week." Really the concept is no different to fireworks going off - another Chinese invention - but which is totally familiar to western observers. Where a visual input has no previous memory planted in human awareness, then the reaction is FEAR and a possible rush of adrenalin which tends to make people suddenly want to communicate and get a rational explanation for what they saw. I once tried out a prank at a routine CIUFOR meeting by placing a hideous "alien" rubber mask on my face and tapping a window of the room where the meeting was taking place. When the mainly female gathering looked round and saw a horrible face peering in, they leapt out of their seats in total shock, which of course was soon neutralised when I came into the room and revealed all. Had I turned tail and slouched off quickly the experience might have remained a mystery and the ladies' fear remain unassuaged.

Many years ago I remarked about the introduction of Jumbo jets, Boeing 747. At the time this huge aircraft stood out like a beacon in the sky compared to the "707s" and "DC8s" it superceded. Nowadays it is well and truly in the memory bank and at a cursory glance seems no different to other smaller passenger aircraft when airborne. The lesser seen and very much smaller Concorde, now obsolete, always demanded to be looked at and not just

very much smaller Concorde, now obsolete, always demanded to be looked at and not just because of the awful noise it made! Of course only a few dozen Concorde were ever built compared to the many 100s of 747s now across the globe. Like rarer birds in the countryside it demanded attention!



THE MYSTERY LIGHTS PASS OVER HIGH RISE FLATS

It is after dark that visual images become distorted and cause confusion. The most common illusion I find is the pillar box which looks like a suspicious person hanging around and a potential mugger. Fear suddenly arises, until only a few yards away, the inert nature of the object is revealed. Once an "unknown" is registered in the human memory system and remains there, then that person may become an ardent UFO devotee at least until their case has been explained. Those witnesses that have the highest level close encounter experiences will forever stick with the subject as what they experienced the one and only time is never replicated.

Shortly we can expect these "Chinese Lantern" reports to become commonplace if more are sold in the UK and eventually nobody will bother to report them just as there are no reports of fireworks around November 5th each year.

LATEST NEWS ITEMS


LATE NEWS - UFO FLEET SPOTTED? We are examining a number of reports describing orange lights which have been seen in the Oxford area on June 1st - 3rd and again on the 10th. There are also similar descriptions from Halesowen and Solihull, West Midlands, and a police officer's report from Wingrave, near Leighton Buzzard, Bucks on June 9th. The lights have been spotted between 10 and 11.30 pm moving in the same direction and totally silent. One or two are first spotted then others come into view. Most

witnesses report between 5 and 8 objects travelling at slow aircraft speed taking 3-5 minutes to pass over. One of the Oxford reports came from a Rugby club outdoor party where an estimated 100+ Persons probably witnessed the phenomenon.

We are satisfied that these objects were NOT Chinese Lanterns which have recently caused a great deal of confusion. Some of the reports received are summarised on the sightings pages.

Channelled information received indicates a possible spectacular UFO display in late September, 2007. We shall see!

2007 CROP CIRCLES - STRONG BUILD-UP: Last year doubters suggested that the 27 year old phenomenon might be on its way out, as circle/ formation numbers fell right back to below 50 in the UK for the whole of the 2006 season. This now looks to be a blip as the 2007 season has started strongly with the first formation in flowering rapeseed arriving on April 15th, a full month before any activity in 2006. The difference can be put down to weather conditions - the 2007 April weather was very warm, whereas both March and April in 2006 were freezing cold. Any formation in rape usually occurs when the plants are at least 4ft tall and in flower, which was the case in April this year. Once the rape crop has podded and the flowers are gone no further circle making activity occurs although the fields are not harvested until August.

This year's first formation was a 330 ft diameter ring containing a series of thin arcs which had geometrical significance. It was located at Oliver's Castle near Devizes, Wilts, at the site where a circle was recorded forming on video back in 1996. The provenance of this film is however still being argued about today. The formation was surprisingly large and well formed for oil seed rape. There followed a series of fairly advanced formations, nearly all of which have been found in Wiltshire, and by mid-June, the total for that county is nearly up to their grand total for 2006. Elsewhere the only early activity has been recorded in Hampshire and a couple in Bedfordshire.

Overseas there have been over 40 formations put through on the Internet by mid-June, with the highest activity being in Italy, which had a goodly number in 2006. The most interesting fact to emerge to date is from Slovenia, where found in their only formation so far was a bird's nest right in the middle of the flattened crop. The circle making energy had been so

gentle that several eggs inside the nest were seen to be TOTALLY UNBROKEN. One supposes that if "plankers" had been responsible for this circle, they would almost certainly have put their boots through the nest!

EARTH LIKE PLANET DISCOVERED: A team of European scientists has discovered a planet, described as "Earth-like" at 20.5 light years distance in space - a comparatively near neighbour. Using the telescope at La Silla, high in the Chilean Andes, the planet has been found orbiting a small red star known as Gilese 581 in the constellation of Libra and is 1½ times the diameter of the Earth.

Although there have so far been 220 planets discovered outside the Solar System, the majority of these are considered far too hot or too cold and may consist entirely of gas rather than solid material - thus not suited for "life". The new discovery, known as "Gilese 581c" has a surface temperature between 0 and 40°C, the right conditions for water to be present. It is accompanied by sister planets "Gilese 581b" and "Gilese 581d". Planet "b" is very close to the parent star and 15 times the size of Earth and so would be too hot for life as we know it. Further out planet "d" is 8 times the diameter of Earth and is considered too cold for habitation. The star Gilese is 50 times colder than our Sun and ½ the size. It can only be seen by the most powerful telescopes. As the planet under investigation is only 6 million miles away from the star, the latter would dominate the skyline as a giant red disc when viewed from the surface. The time for one orbit is only 13 Earth days, so this fact and the effect of gravity still make the possibility of "life" somewhat questionable. However the new discovery is a very good "SETI" possibility and future advances in telescopes and space exploration will no doubt focus here.

It is still not clear if scientists are aware of the total requirements for even the most basic form of "life" to be created on any planet, and "intelligence" is an even greater step forward. Just because the atmosphere is right, water is present, and the temperature not too hot or too cold does not guarantee "life" will be found on any planet other than our own. There is surely a "missing link" yet to be discovered-----

STAFFORDSHIRE UFO GROUP DISBANDS: One of the liveliest small UFO groups unfortunately agreed to disband in February 2007. Chairman, Graham Allen, the founder of the group, announced his retirement through ill health and it appears no successor was forthcoming. Member Cliff Harris said the closure is "the end of an era. The world of British UFO research and investigation is a poorer place after the announcement of the SUFOG closure", he said.

LIVINGSTON INCIDENT WITNESS DIES: Forestry worker, Bob Taylor, who was the sole witness in a major UFO landing mystery died in March, aged 89. This amazing case remains unsolved after 28 years.

Bob Taylor was out walking his dog on November 9th, 1979, in Dechmont Woods, Livingston, West Lothian, Scotland, when he came across a 20 ft diameter "sphere" in a clearing. Two robotic smaller spheres with arms, resembling sea mines, emerged from the larger object and rolled towards Bob attaching themselves to his trousers. An acrid smell was emitted and Bob passed out. When he came to 20 minutes later, his head was pounding and he could neither talk or walk. Somehow he managed to crawl back to his truck and drive home. He was found to have lacerations on his legs and his trousers were badly torn,

but had no injuries to the upper body or head. The trousers have subsequently been in the safe keeping of paranormal investigator, Malcolm Robinson, and are the only artifact from the incident. Police examined the scene and found several ladder shaped indentations in the ground. Later a plaque was erected at the site of the incident which unfortunately was stolen sometime afterwards. Bob Taylor moved away from the area shortly after and died in a nursing home from bronchial pneumonia - clearly not as a consequence of his 1979 experience.

On the 25th anniversary of the event, Bob spoke in public saying he could recall the incident as if it were yesterday, and it was the most amazing thing that had happened to him.

CHILEAN LAKE VANISHES: A 5 acre sized lake in a remote area of Chile known as The Megallanes region, was found drained of all its water by rangers on patrol in May. Nothing was left but a crater and chunks of ice that used to float on the surface. On their last visit in March, there was a full expanse of water present. This region is known to be geologically unstable and an earth tremor may have opened up a fissure through which the water drained away. The possibility remains however that UFO activity may have been responsible. There have been several reports from South America of water being drawn up into UFOs, and this very isolated spot would be the ideal place where no witnesses were present.

AGONY CORNER. (Anti-establishment comment on latest scares and cover-ups).
MORE FUN WITH ELECTRONICS! We have talked about the effects of mobile phones and microwave towers on the human anatomy many times previously. Needless to say the numbers of these items are increasing without check accompanied with the always complacent statement that radiation levels are within "safe limits". Of course nobody is fully aware of the long term effects of accumulated doses of microwaves, which is made apparent when clusters of cancers are found amongst residents living close to a tower. A recent outbreak was examined at Coleshill, Warwickshire, where a staggering number of sick people were reported in one street, just a few hundred yards from a microwave tower.

All of a sudden there is a new device raising its ugly cancerous head! As this is called "WIRELESS", one thought it harped back to the days when when early radio sets were known as "wirelesses". It seems not, as this modern invention is literally WIRE LESS or WI-FI and beams out radiation which can pump Internet and E-mail connections straight into computers. The downside is that an "electronic smog" surrounds the device and already users are complaining of headaches and nausea. In particular schools are installing a particularly powerful wireless system to activate banks of computers used by whole classes with the result that pupils are losing concentration and get headaches. Smaller home devices used to transmit "Broadband" signals produce dowsable effects within about one metre away from the rectangular box supplied, and as the radiation only appears to come from the front of the box, it is recommended that users place the device sideways to their body.

On May 26th, 2007, a "Panorama" TV investigation showed that the signal strength from a wireless transmitter was 3 times greater than that from a microwave tower at 300 yards distance. They also revealed that 8 towns or cities in the UK had a network of wireless hubs which could power up all the computers in the near vicinity. In the fair city of Norwich, the hubs were pointed out on lamp posts resembling alien "pods" from "The Invasion of the Body Snatchers"! Thus visitors to these places are now bathed in an "electronic smog" from wireless connections, microwave towers and mobile phones in use. Better stay in the country if you can avoid the hidden masts in the church towers, woodland glades etc!

CONSPIRACY UPDATE:

BOB WOOLMER - CONSPIRACY OR NO CONSPIRACY? The vastly experienced cricket coach of Pakistan (and formerly South Africa) was found dead in his hotel bathroom, in Kingston, Jamaica on March 18th 2007, shortly after his team had been defeated by no-hopers Ireland in the Cricket World Cup. The post mortem on Mr Woolmer's body eventually claimed he had been strangled although there were no marks on the neck. It is unlikely that a single person would have been strong enough to subdue the weighty coach who was over 6ft tall and weighed at least 16 stones. Amounts of sick and faeces were found in the bathroom, and it was later suggested that Woolmer may have been poisoned to weaken him up and then strangled. The use of the poison ACONITE was suggested as this had been used to remove certain Pakistani politicians. Even weed killer from the cricket pitch was hinted at.

The motive for removing Bob Woolmer centred on the notion he was about to unveil the working of illegal betting syndicates in India and Pakistan, places where this type of activity is endemic. Even disgruntled fans were suggested to have attacked him following the shock defeat the day before, but whoever it was must have been invited into the hotel room by Woolmer himself as no forced entry had been made or duplicate electronic pass cards used. The CCTV images from the corridor outside were studied for weeks but no suspicious persons noted.

Scotland Yard specialists were later flown to Jamaica to check on the findings, and could find no evidence that lead deputy police chief, Mark Shields, to call for a murder investigation in the first instance. Three independent assessments agree that Woolmer was a very sick man with an enlarged heart and was on medication for severe diabetes, so they concurred that the 58 year old coach had collapsed and died from natural causes, and the other circumstances were just coincidence. The post mortem carried out by overworked Kingston pathologist, Dr Ere Sessaiah, claimed that a bone in Woolmer's neck had fractured due to strangulation, but the British experts said his conclusion was flawed - the bone was intact.

Where there has been a history of drug taking, match fixing, ball tampering and illegal payments in the past - as has been recorded with the Pakistan team - the Woolmer incident would be seen as grist to the mill, and conspiracy theories would obviously power their way through pushing out objectivity. Had Woolmer coached say the squeaky clean New Zealand team, no doubt a murder investigation would be the last possibility to arise rather than the first! Alternatively, after 3 months investigation the police had come up with no suspects or certain motives, and the case was creating political problems in Pakistan, so the easy way out would be to quote natural causes and let poor old Dr Sessaiah take the flak!


CONSPIRACY OR NO CONSPIRACY?

LITVINENKO: The man poisoned by Polonium - 210 in London, last November, Alexander Litvinenko, has been the subject of a massive investigation. Now at last it has been announced that one of the former Russian agents Litvinenko met on November 1st at the Millennium Hotel, central London, Andrei Lugavoi, has been accused of poisoning him - slipping the Polonium into a teapot. Apparently wherever Lugavoi went on his business round London and on aircraft, trails of radioactivity were picked up. The problem is that Lugavoi is firmly back in Moscow and the chances of extraditing him to Britain are extremely slim. Lugavoi maintains his absolute innocence and claims he too was a victim of Polonium

poisoning.

On May 31st, 2007, Lugavoi suddenly elected to give a news conference in Moscow in which he accused Litvinenko of working for the British Secret Service, M16, and had himself been subject to persuasive overtures to "come over"! There is no doubt so much misinformation being spouted over this case, that a complete smokescreen is now in place. The activities are starting to resemble old tricks used by the Russians during the "Cold War".

Andrei Lugavoi: Denies any involvement in the murder

PRINCESS DIANA: The ten year wait for an inquest in public court still looks unresolved with the departure of the appointed judge, Lady Butler-Schloss. The main activist in all this, Dodi Fayad's father, owner of Harrod's store is still insisting he will have the Queen, Duke of Edinburgh and Prince Charles in the witness box. (Pigs may fly!) Yet another book on Diana's life has just been published, by New York socialite, Tina Brown, exposing her very sad passages through life. Perhaps fate destined her end the way it happened?

SIGHTING REPORT

Date: 18/01/07 **Country:** UK
Place: Slough, Berkshire **Time:** 15.15

Mr S U was clearing some trees after a very heavy storm and saw a bright silver object which appeared to be travelling south from Slough. It paused over the old Co-op site nearby, then headed off down Wellington Street where it disappeared.

The object was travelling at the same height as a plane and appeared to be hovering overhead. Mr U was certain it was not a plane as it was not on the normal flight path and did not leave a vapour trail. He did manage to photograph the object but when the pictures were developed he was disappointed as the object appeared much smaller than he thought and was not clearly distinguishable. A neighbour managed to scan the photos in his computer and they were able to get a clearer view which showed a strange crescent shaped object in the clouds. Mr U was relieved it showed something unusual as he knew that he had seen something that was unidentifiable.

Date: 14/03/2007 **Country:** UK
Place: Biggleswade, Bedford **Time:** 22.30

Mr D G saw approximately 40 red and blue spinning lights in the western sky at Biggleswade, Bedfordshire. Three witnesses watched the lights for forty minutes then went off to bed. Contact informed Directorate of Air Staff, at the MOD who stated they had received no reports of anything strange in the sky for Biggleswade on that date. Contact also asked Bedfordshire Police who confirmed there were no Police operations requiring helicopter support that evening which ruled out any low flying air craft in the vicinity. The conclusion was the objects were unexplained.

Date: 09/03/07 **Country:** UK
Place: Daventry, Nortants **Time: approx** 19.30

A female witness telephoned Contact on the 11/03/07 stating she had seen something unusual in the sky as she was standing just across the road from her house waiting for a friend to pick her up. She noticed coming from the west low in the sky what looked like a ball of red flame heading in her direction. At first she thought it was a plane on fire and about to come down, although there was no smoke and feeling rather apprehensive because it was heading for the houses near to where she lived. The object came nearer and she could see it was not a fire but a large red light which cast a haze giving appearance of being larger. It was travelling at the speed of a plane, was about the size of a dustbin and height of a helicopter roughly. It travelled in a straight trajectory and could see some sort of cone shape attached to the light.

Her friend arrived to give her a lift and she lost sight of it behind her neighbour's house but she was hopeful to see it again as they drove along the road but there was no sign of it anywhere.

Date: 23/04/07 **Country:** UK
Place: Channel Islands **Time: approx** 15.00

Two experienced airline pilots on separate flights saw something up to a "mile" wide off the coast of Alderney.

Captain Ray Bowyer said he saw a bright yellow flat disc shaped light 10 miles west of Alderney whilst his plane was about 30 miles from the island and at 4,000ft. "It was a very sharp thin yellow object with a green area. It was 2000 ft up and stationary. I thought it was about 10 miles away although I later realised it was probably approximately 40 miles away. As I came close, it became

clear to me that it was tangible. I was in two minds about going towards it to have a closer look but decided against it because of its size and I had to think of the safety to my passengers first".

He stated it could have been as much as a mile wide and had never seen anything like it before in his flying career. He also stated he was quite shocked at the experience.

As he continued his approach to Alderney, Captain Bowyer saw a second identical object further to the west which appeared closer to Guernsey.

He has been flying commercial planes for about 20 years and said he described the objects to air traffic control and filled in an incident report.

Paul Kelly, the duty traffic controller said a Blue Islands pilot had made a similar report but there was nothing on the radar possibly due to the object(s) being stationary.

The other pilot was en route to Jersey at the same time and as he went past Sark Island he described an object behind him and to his left. The description was very similar to Captain Bowyers and they both described it being in exactly the same place but they were looking at it from opposite sides. The second pilot said it was beneath his plane at 1,500 feet (he was at 3,500 ft at the time so both pilots placed it at the same altitude).

Reports were sent to the MOD for further investigation.

French military air space starts 20 miles west of Guernsey and occupies an area of approximately 150 square miles. British military air space starts 40 miles north of Guernsey and Captain Queripel believes military involvement was the likeliest explanation. He had seen Ray Bowyer 45 minutes after the incident and he was clearly shaken. He obviously saw something and without appearing to discredit his story Captain Queripel said military air spaces around the island are off limits to commercial planes. "They are called danger areas for a reason, enter them at your peril. You can ask for permission to go through but it would usually be denied". He felt the obvious explanation was that the military were testing a new technology that has not been seen before.

Editor note: (sigh: where have we heard that before.)

There have been several telephone calls and e-mails regarding UFO sightings and here are just a few of them.

29/04/07 M54 East 15 miles from Telford UK at 19.30 hrs, weather conditions were good, bright and sunny. A couple travelling home from Telford saw a bright silver reflective object ellipse in shape and attached beneath it were 2 black appendages triangular in shape. It seemed about the size of a Ford KA. and looked to be a few hundred feet up. They could clearly see it from the motorway and other drivers must have seen it.

01/06/07 10.40pm Halesowen, West Midlands.UK A man went to close his front room curtains and saw 5 orange disc shaped objects coming out of the Eastern horizon. He called his wife and daughters and they watched the objects fly overhead, two of them seemed to move faster than the others. They ran to the rear of the house and watched them fly off to the west. They made no noise, had no flashing strobe lights and certainly did not look like aircraft of any description. He is a keen astronomer with binoculars and is familiar with moving objects in the night sky.

02/06/07 22.30 Oxford UK A female witness was at a Rugby Club BBQ after popping inside the club she came out and noticed all of the people looking skyward at 7 or 8 fairly large orange lights in the sky. She said everybody was interested and some were taking photos of the objects as they passed overhead. She stated they were obviously not aircraft of any description and were too close together to be flying in formation as a group of planes. They all watched for several minutes and then one by one, seemingly as they reached the same point in the sky they all disappeared. It was not like going over the horizon and sailing out of view they literally disappeared at the same spot in the sky.

21.10.2000 This lady S.Hughes from Prestatyn had gone to fetch her son, aged 15 from High School when between two houses on the Meliden/Rhuddlan Road they saw a bright light fall between two houses, next it was beside their car and followed them, stopping when they stopped and starting again when they did, finally it stopped when they reached their rented house, she immediately went in doors feeling unnerved, but her son seemed unafraid as he stayed outside to watch the light shoot off

22.10.2000 D.Parker and Keith ... had been working on the railway lines by the beach at Pensarn, Abergele when further up the line they saw a big round white light with no sound came down and alight on the railway line about ¼ mile from them, it eventually flew away.

On the 4th September 2000 KW had reported his weird UFO experience by Pensarn Beach and the railway line running near by, this happened at the same locality in 1972 and which I relate in my book Who are they?

At the end of November 2000 the Witness Mrs Williams had got up to go to the toilet in her upstairs bed room between 1-2 am. She looked out of the back window which has a panoramic view of the mountains of Snowdonia. The area round Bethesda has open cast mining, and it was on the bare mountain opposite that she saw what she described "as a match-stick man with a tin hat on, on a penny farthing bicycle, coming down from the sky (a very clear night, many stars) then it peddled down the mountain slope and then going down it till this apparition disappeared from her view in to the Quarry below". On going over this with the Lady and making sketches, it seemed the lit up helmet which was small, was the usual shape of UFOs of that description. A black stick at a slant connected it to the two circles below which had spokes of light coming from the centre and the circles themselves had bright white lights around their perimeters. One was much smaller than the other, hence the penny farthing description. The mechanism between peddled furiously, but neither the hat shape or circles rotated, neither did they tilt downwards going down the steep mountain side. This it did very slowly so she was able to take in details. This Irish lady was in her early 60's, educated and a good witness. Maureen Punsord and I went a number of times to the area and made a very careful assessment of this. Mrs and Mr. Williams then went on to have a few more sightings of UFO round their house. They passed over the roof, then to the side of the house to the front.. I have made a sketch overleaf as I have lost the original sketches.

5.8.2001 Elwyn Jones phoned me again about the extraordinary experience of the Lady in Snowdonia, wife of a Welsh TV personality. He was able to add that he had found circles of burnt grass in the field afterwards, when he went to examine it. The Professional Lady was going through a painful divorce and that was why he had not taken it further. Had this experience of hers put a great strain on the marriage I wondered?

23rd October 2001 A. Rawlinson WFIU member went down to Wrexham to buy a book, he had his camera with him and decided to take a photo of St. Giles Church Wrexham. When the film was developed there was a distinct sausage shape by the Spire with a 'cocktail stick sticking out of the middle' Photo copy enclosed.

8.6.2004 See David Owen Jones report overleaf. As he lived with a view opposite of Bodfari and the T.V mast on Moel Foel it is not surprising this young man sees UFOs frequently over the years. I get reports from this area ever years since I have been in North Wales 23 years.

9.9.2004 Mr. Simkiss sitting in his garden at Holywell saw silvery 'things' going extremely fast across the sky. Every few seconds they came together, then they shot away from each other His wife was with him, but did not see them as her long distance vision is no good and she did not have spectacles with her. See his sketch over leaf..

16.9.2004 B. Williams was watching his 11 yrs. old son who was playing a game of football at their football Club Mold. There were 15 youngsters plus the Instructor and Coach. They all stopped playing as they watched 8 to 10 silver discs pass over, right across the sky. Adults and children sat on the grass watching this, they forgot the game and they phoned Speke Airport and Jodrell Bank. Report given me by the boy in the football team and the father.

18.4.2005 A report was sent me by a Mrs Everson about what she saw at 12.30 a.m. (month?) 1986 at Rossett Chester-by-Pass. She was in her car, it was clear day light and this long Object with long oblong windows lit up, looking just like a train in the sky passed quite low over this main road. She had only recently got my address and someone gave her a Report Form, whom I never discovered, as she did not write again though she wrote down her address.

16.5.2005 John White of Llanefydd over a period of months videoed what he thought were UFOs crossing the night sky from May onwards. Ralph Vaughan ret: RAF and John Roberts ret:Police my WFIU Investigator/researchers joined Mr. White on a few occasions and were of the opinion that though he genuinely felt he was videoing UFOs most of these were planets. They gave him charts of the Sky at Night during that period, but he was unconvinced. However, on one of these occasions when with their wives they all saw what they genuinely thought were two UFOs crossing the sky. This tied in with the time and date Dave Owen Jones and some of his friends in Denbigh had a much closer view of presumably the same crafts See overleaf.

26.6.2005 D.O Jones rang to say he had seen a long cigar shaped white craft, with long oblong windows lit-up pass low to the Clwydian mountains. He and some young men friends were standing in his garden at Denbigh, watching this, the time coincided with the times of one of Mr. White's videos of this seen at a distance. Llanefydd being on higher hills than Denbigh. So no doubt Mr. White did on occasions video actual UFOs.

During 2002 and 2004 I met a lady called Daisy Harbour, at a friend's house in Penrhyn Bay. Daisy was then in her early 90s, very sprightly in possession of all her faculties. She often told me about the extraordinary experience she had years back when her Welsh husband and she had a small holding in B - A. Leicestershire. One evening as it was getting dark,

they heard a whirling sound, and a round craft with revolving lights came down into the adjoining field and settled on the ground. It had revolving lights at its base and was shaped like a shallow saucer turned up side down. They ran out and stood at the entrance to the field. Most of the people in the Hamlet did, but one rash youth ran up and jumped on it. They all yelled at him to get down., he did, after some moments, but fell on his knees. Seven months later he died of cancer of the knees. Daisy had a large framed photo of this circle of burnt out grass in the grass field with her house alongside.

Daisy died about 2004 and my friend then put me in touch last year 2005 with her Granddaughter living in Colwyn Bay. I asked if I may have a copy of Daisy's photo, she said she did not have it, but would try to find out who got it amongst her relatives.

This lady gave me a different version of the event. She said she was 14 at the time, she thought it was the late afternoon, her family did go and stand at the entrance to the field; which belonged to another farmer. That her boy friend aged 18 did run up to the place the UFO landed in the grass, AFTER it took off, the earth was scorched and he fell on his knees in it. He died of cancer seven months later. So whose version was correct?

John Hanson who travels the UK investigating UFO reports has promised to take me to the area and we will investigate further maybe next year. To the granddaughter's knowledge, her boyfriend's family and their neighbours still live there.

11.11.2004 James Willmott and Dwyn two 21 years old young men phoned me from Bristol. They were on holiday in the Mumbles South Wales and were on the beach when they saw a large light 'on the beach,' they decided to send flashes with their Everready torch to see what it was and if it would respond. It then turned a bright yellow, then a bright red, then it seemed to jump a distance in the air, then it returned and so on. I think they decided to beat a hasty retreat, but they had obviously thought it a strange thing and were quite excited when they phoned me as soon as they got home to Bristol, to ask if I thought it was a UFO?

29th March 2005 Alex Mera witnessed a dark coloured cigar shaped object in the sky whilst at Ros Caravan Park Anglesey N.Wales whilst on holiday. The Object was viewed for 4 minutes at 5 p.m. during this time the Object moved from right to left, then arched upwards and ascended into a cloud. He checked with the Met Office & RAF Anglesey. The cloud level was 12,000 ft. wind 8 knots westerly. The Object was metallic and had no wings or sound. He saw this with his two granddaughters and a couple they met on Lygwy beach said they had also seen it.

6.8.2005 at 11 p.m. Andrew Schnell went out into the garden to smoke, because his wife does not permit him to smoke in the house (neither do I let my husband) then he saw a large light low down quite stationary for 3 minutes, which pulsed it went towards the North, then remained stationary again for a couple of minutes, then it just faded out.

23.1.2006 John Roberts our WFIU investigator and his wife Julie had gone for an outing to Rhos on Sea our prettiest sea side resort, when waiting in a queue for the lights to turn, he saw what he thought was a UFO, oval with a dome to the side, just over the sea by the harbour. He had his camera and took a photo of it. We have to have this enlarged, he has shifted house and the opportunity for this hasn't arisen yet. It certainly looks like a UFO.

9th February 2006 Penrhyn Bay.N. Wales 6.20 a.m. A Father and son saw a bright ball pass over the Bay early in the morning, it was low and silent. It went on a regular course sometimes behind clouds. It also had flashing red lights unlike a normal aircraft

14. August 2006 at approx 22 hrs Grid Ref: SJO72665 an aircraft flying S to N roughly from the town of Ruthin to St.Asaph following the River Clwyd always about 500ft..a very low altitude. An engineer in the Denbighshire Council Neil Owen E mailed me this through BBC Wales. Apparently he saw this at close quarters, I phoned and also E Mailed asking what the Craft looked like. Instead he said he was reporting this to the RAF authorities and had written a letter to Low Flying Air Traffic Control, and would send me a copy when he received a reply, this he did, but he would not respond to repeated requests as to what he actually saw, and could we (the WFIU) meet him

13th October 2006, 21.45 to 22.20 Witness a 24 years old man D.O.Jones saw seven lights near the T.V mast at Moel Foel Denbigh district. His house is opposite. Each light was a different colour – green, yellow, white, red, blue some disappeared but came back and changed positions for the duration of the sighting. Each gradually dimmed and left at various minutes of the duration of the Sighting. Then they flew towards his house and passed over. He sent detailed sketches and he agreed to the WFIU interviewing him.

On the 4th October 2006 Sally Gavin and her boyfriend of Llanynys saw a very bright light flashing over Moel Famau Country Park. It grew wider and wider and consisted of three lights which flashed on and off like a Christmas tree lights before disappearing. She called a friend living at Gellifor and he said he was also watching the lights, it was hovering just above the mountain. Five people in all including Sally's brother-in-law saw this and reported this to the North Wales Police who predictably said it might be the Army (doing what?) and even more lame an explanation -someone out hunting!

The Denbighshire Free Press wrote this up, misquoting and inaccurately describing previous reports they got off BBC N.W. Weird Wales website, which I do with Nick Bourne the Producer. After this our WFIU tried several times to arrange to go to Denbigh and interview these witnesses. They would say they would meet us, and then not follow the arrangements through, so we just had to give up, they were too unreliable. There is a chance though that we may still meet D.O. Jones, he cancelled our interview because he had to have emergency dental treatment on a Sunday! We could be forgiven for thinking this was all 'bulls,' but subsequently we read in the local newspaper that Rhyl does an Emergency Dental Clinic on a Sunday!


EARTH MYSTERIES - LOCAL INVESTIGATION OF ST MICHAEL AND ST MARY LINES

The wonderful book "The Sun and the Serpent" by Paul Broadhurst and Hamish Miller relates how these explorers traced the major leys or energy lines, "St Michael" and "St Mary" all the way from St Michael's Mount, Cornwall to the North Sea in Norfolk in a marathon "yomp" across country in 1988-9. At first they were only looking to dowse Michael but by the time they reached Avebury in Wiltshire - the "Clapham Junction" of ley lines, they were aware of a second major line running close to and occasionally crossing Michael, which is now known as the St Mary line. The intrepid pair returned to Cornwall and started all over again!

Eventually Broadhurst and Miller reached Oxfordshire where they found the lines passing through and meeting at ancient hillforts and certain churches. Using the guidelines from "The Sun and the Serpent", I have endeavoured to locate Michael and Mary in my own locality, which is about 6 miles east of Oxford, and explore further. To my mind fresh knowledge can only be acquired by walking many miles across country and "being there" - rather than rehash material from books.

The first job was to ascertain the dowsing profile of Michael and Mary at known locations along the route traversed by Broadhurst and Miller. At Clifton Hampden there is a splendid village church of St Michael perched on a mound overlooking the River Thames. Here I found very strong dowsing of the Michael line going right through the aisle of the church, as one continuous width, approx 35ft or 10 metres, with my pair of dowsing rods crossing over each other. A few miles away at Dorchester Abbey, the Mary line was located running all the way down the full length of the Abbey. The nature of this energy was completely different - consisting of 2 parts, a section of about 10ft width where the rods crossed over, a gap of about 6ft, and a further 10ft zone where the rods opened out, I.E moved in the opposite direction to the first section. See sketches below.



This weird two part arrangement held true wherever I located Mary in the area. I even checked it out at the Hurlers stone circle in Cornwall more than 200 miles away, which is a known meeting point of the two leys. Just what deep down in the ground can cause the dowsing rods to abruptly change direction over a few feet and continue in this form of partnership for many miles? For some reason Hamish Miller does not discuss the fine detail of what movements of the dowsing rods are likely to be experienced when detecting the Michael and Mary lines. These may be because different people get different reactions or no reactions at all. I consider myself ultra sensitive to detecting energy lines having spent years dowsing crop circles.


Of course any disturbance in the ground such as buried cables and pipes will bring about a dowsing reaction. At the Hurlers, buried cables running across Bodmin Moor are denoted by marker stones every 100 yards or so. These dowsed a 4ft wide line with rods crossing over, compared to the 35ft wide Michael line just yards away, so there was no real comparison.

Having established what movements to expect on the dowsing rods, I endeavoured to plot as many positions as possible for both lines in my local area, by checking along roads, bridle paths and fields where possible, and see what extra knowledge was obtainable. The Michael line was followed from Clifton Hampden church (position C on diagram), through another church at Little Wittenham (position B) to a nodal point with the Mary line at Sinodun, a prehistoric hillfort on the local nature reserve known as Wittenham Clumps near Didcot. (positions A and 11). According to the "Sun and the Serpent", the Michael line should have then headed up north through the churches at Marsh Baldon, Garsington and Cuddesdon. At the first 2 places I detected no leys at all, and at Cuddesdon the energy fitted the Mary profile. Is it possible for a major leyline to move or not be detectable - probably not, as positions further east in Buckinghamshire quoted in the book gave full positive dowsing of the Michael line. One theory passed to me is that the church of St Mary, Garsington has its tower supported by scaffolding and metal sheeting which creates a "Faraday Cage" possibly affecting energy flows in the area. Apart from the 3 locations down near the Thames (positions A,B,C), I was unable to find the Michael line anywhere else on my foot slog. However the Mary line was located at 26 positions in a ten mile survey in which the ley was found to run north from Sinodun to Cuddesdon and then loop round and turn back south. (See diagram).


It is clear that these lines duck and weave all over the countryside, "serpentlike", Hamish Miller's dowsing of the whole route would not spot all the subtle movements unless he spent many years at it. The general route of the lines from Cornwall to Norfolk can be followed via the more famous monuments on route such as Glastonbury Tor and Avebury, but the underground disturbances that were created millions of years ago are laid down in erratic fashion like the naturally formed rivers we can see on the surface of the planet. For instance the Thames runs from near Cirencester, Glos, to the North Sea near Southend and is measured at 205 miles length. The distance, as the crow flies, is only 125 miles - so over much of its length the Thames makes serpent like turns and changes of direction to add extra miles. At places near Henley it is difficult to tell what is upstream or downstream!

Starting at the delightful village of Cuddesdon the St Mary line ducked and weaved seemingly in all directions. It passed directly across the All Saints church exactly in alignment with the wide side entrance and passed right through the theological college, where clergy are trained, just up the road. (positions 1,2). A memorial statue or obelisk mounted just inside the college grounds was dowsed as being placed exactly between the 2 halves of the flow - by accident or design? It should be noted that no mention of being on a leyline is referred to on the noticeboard or website of any church I visited. Many churches were built on old pagan worship sites where the presence of ley energy was revered, but is now clearly a taboo subject.

Further up the road from Cuddesdon a huge tree by the roadside was found to be spot on the Mary line (position 4). This was remarkable in that the trunk was split in three arms at ground level, and it was far bigger than any other tree in the neighbourhood. At other locations trees were also found to have this three way split where growing on the Mary line including the nearby churchyard at Little Milton, where a concealed holly-like tree at the





back of St James church was split low on the trunk in the same manner. (position 6). Mary ran right through this church and into old thatched cottages on the opposite side of the A329. This seemed a bit surprising as St James was only constructed in the 1850s possibly after knowledge of ley lines was lost.

Further on towards Stadhampton, the Mary line passed between 2 old stone pillars which looked at one time to mark the driveway up to a stately home, but now lost in a jungle of weeds by the side of the B480. (position 8). Only farm buildings could be seen in the vicinity. The flow was then picked up again entering the ancient wooden church at Drayton St Leonard (position 9) and on to Dorchester Abbey (position 10).

As mentioned the flows of Michael and Mary cross over at Sinodun (position 11). The actual meeting point is in a copse of trees at the highest point which has been fenced off - stated as being in a dangerous condition. Could this be due to the meeting of energies upsetting growth patterns amongst the trees? CIUFOR has conducted many skywatches at this location and tales of devil worship and witchcraft around here have been reported. What is not answered by anyone for obvious reasons is whether the two major leys intermingle directly with each other or merely pass over at different levels below the ground at such places as Sinodun.

Back to Cuddesdon in the opposite direction, I found the Mary line crossing a mile long field of rapeseed and running across the Wheatley - Garsington road at position 14. Somewhere around here the line makes a dramatic change of direction and heads back south passing through a thatched cottage at Garsington village (position 16). This cottage was the only one along the road here so may have knowingly been placed on the energy years ago. I was able to trace the Mary line in fields south of here and found it passed through a mobile home site where it crossed the B480 (position 18). On the opposite side of the road it ran through the field where crop circles have been reported for many years (position 21) and must have passed across the other ley line here which was investigated in Awareness Vol 28 No 2 as part of the Crop Circle Report for 2006. Near Toot Baldon, Mary crossed the road (position 22) just clipping the side of an isolated house which was recently burnt down in mysterious circumstances and remains a fenced off ruin.

A final strange location was at position 23 along a bridle path just outside Toot Baldon village where Mary passed over a series of sunken ponds. A tree positioned in the open rods zone of the energy had died whereas another located where the rods crossed over was massive and vigorous. It can be argued that the St Mary line may be a combination of good and bad energies operating in tandem.

I followed the twisting road between Toot Baldon and Marsh Baldon and found a few more Mary crossovers giving 26 downsable points in all. The next task is to find out exactly where the St Michael line runs as I was unable to detect it in my local area according to the positions given in "The Sun and the Serpent" having last located it along the banks of the Thames.

Is all this activity worthwhile or not - good country walks with a purpose I think, and the chance of discovering something very unusual and mysterious. Apart from Broadhurst and Miller's investigation it seems there is very little other knowledge available at a local level away from the stone circles and major crossing points of Michael and Mary, so let's do it!

YOU AND ME

In a recent article in CUFORO (Vol.3 No.2, Whole No.18, 1974) it looked like there was a change of attitude both in public opinion and with the authorities in regard to the UFO subject.

Now events are beginning to move fast. I have already mentioned in that earlier article the interest there is in France about the UFO scene, and the fantastic number of UFO programmes broadcast from French-Inter in the Spring of last year, including an interview with the then French Minister of Defence, Monsieur, Robert Galley.

In the United States, Dr J. Allen Hynek's UFO Study Centre in Evanston, Illinois, is collecting thousands of nationwide UFO reports with the co-operation of the police, the FBI and the Civil Defence Agency.

It has been established without any shadow of doubt that the US Air Force, Project Bluebook, was a complete cover-up and that the US Air Force kept certain evidence away from the public. Recently a fantastic two hour documentary film has been shown dealing with the UFO cover-up by the US Air Force and the Pentagon. Additionally, SAGA's UFO REPORT (Fall, 1975) carried a well documented article on the same theme.

I have been criticised for writing one or two of my books that there has been a cover-up. Now I am being vindicated.

However, I did also make the point that possibly the authorities were right in one sense to "cover-up" some years ago, because if they had announced that UFOs existed, then this would have laid them open to some very awkward questions to which they may not have had the answers. Nevertheless, I did suggest that the authorities should have gone some way with the general education of the public towards a gradual acceptance of the UFOs.

Anyway the UFOs have gone on appearing in our skies with increased frequency, and have been reported consistently all over the world in even greater numbers than before. It would seem that the ufonauts have done the job for the authorities!

More than 15 million Americans claim to have seen UFOs. If we add that impressive figure to the overall world total the answer surely must be astronomical!

I believe that either one or two things are going to happen very soon. (1) There could be an announcement from the authorities that UFOs exist, or (2) that shortly the ufonauts will make a general open landing. This second possibility may occur after either some catastrophe or nuclear war. However, I think that it could occur before. I hope so.

Incidentally, I am not discussing Inner Earth people in this context. Your readers will recall that I wrote about them and a hollow Earth in a recent article. I have now received information (which has got to be checked out - you may well ask How?) that space people are already inside the Earth getting rid of undesirable elements.

Now the whole purpose of this article is to suggest to all ufologists that the time has come to take a look at our priorities. Although we should continue to investigate UFO sighting reports, analyse and fit them into patterns, we ought to be turning to something far more important and imperative.

Yes of course we must go on investigating and doing research work, but surely enough evidence has been collected during the past quarter of a century or more, to prove that UFOs exist. They have been seen by millions of people; photographs and films have been made of them; substances have been collected at landing sites, and still we go on with this continuous obsession that demands thousands more reports must be collected and filed away in archives. The ufonauts must think us ufologists somewhat "round the bend"!

In a Court of Law it would only need 2 or 3 witnesses to give evidence that a man has committed a murder for a conviction to be secured. Yet in this Alice in Wonderland situation of the UFOs, apparently millions of witnesses do not count for anything. We could go on collecting, investigating, analysing and filing away reports for another quarter of a century and probably not be much wiser.

What I am putting forward is a constructive idea. If the UFOs exist, and most of CUFORO's readers will, I think, go along with that, and if they are shortly going to land here (and I admit this is a considered speculative guess based on a hunch. I would add for what it is worth my hunches usually come off!), then we ought to be thinking about something else.

Now what do I mean by that? Just this - the UFOs chiefly reported and publicised in the Americas, Europe and South Africa. The rest of the world including the Soviet Union, and Asia have their fair share too, but the inhabitants of these countries have not been able to read about UFO incidents in their newspapers to the same extent as in the West. We know that the Soviet Union and other countries behind the Iron Curtain have had many UFO sightings because of a book called "UFOs From Behind the Iron Curtain" by Ion Hobana and Julien Weverbergh (Souvenir Press, London, 1974), which I reviewed a little while ago for CUFORO. Contact International, of which I am President, has many member countries. A recent one is Taiwan, sometimes known as Formosa. My new friend who is heading Contact International (Taiwan) states quite clearly that people in his country have little or no information on the UFOs. I am sure that UFOs have been seen in Taiwan (Formosa), but the Chinese people - and the same goes for China itself - are too preoccupied in trying to cope with the difficulties of Life itself. I also think as was expressed in the book mentioned earlier that communist countries do not appreciate the UFO business, as it might be a threat to their control over their people.

I think our main task now (though reports should be investigated and dealt with properly) would be to educate the public about a possible open landing by the ufonauts. They should, as far as possible, be screened from a possible traumatic experience.

This can only be done by communication, and by telling them that most of the UFO sightings, landings and other phenomena, have been harmless. One cannot prove it, but, I think that it is worth keeping an open mind on the possibility. Sooner or later technology had to do it.



BOOK REVIEW.

You know there are a number of great working researchers in the field of UFO research, many of them unsung heroes; Ryan S Wood is one of these. Ryan works tirelessly finding and assessing reports regarding crashes of 'flying saucers'. He not only seeks these reports from the United States, but searches for them from all corners of the Earth. Of course one would think that if these 'flying saucers' were travelling from other worlds or other dimensions that it would seem improbable that they would come so far only to crash on a foreign planet. Whilst that may seem a reasonable statement and assumption to make, there are reasons given (which I'll come to shortly) that explains why crashes would happen. Of course for the Joe Bloggs or the proverbial 'man in the street' he is more likely to know about the crash at Roswell New Mexico than he is of the crash at Easter Somaliland in 1996 as depicted in this book. However, that said, this is a fantastic collection of 'alleged' UFO crashes brought together for public consumption and as such deserves your attention. OK, let us take a look at what's going on here.

In Ryan's introduction he informs the reader about the Government's stance on the UFO situation and covers a number of documents pertaining to interesting UFO accounts and also discusses how under the Freedom of Information Act a plethora of documents and incidents which truly are eyebrow raising were released to the general public. For me the opening introduction chapter is by far the most interesting in the whole book for Ryan has really dug deep and turned up a plethora of facts and figures which just screams out to be read. An example in point is the SOM 1-01 Extraterrestrial Entities And Technology Recovery And Disposal document, classed as 'Top Secret/Majic Eyes Only. If this is a true document and not a 'plant' well jeez oh this is the document to top all documents. !

This book of course portrays worldwide UFO crashes and if truth be told, a number of them have limited and minimal information. The Llandegla Welsh case of December 1965 covers only half a page and to all intents and purposes seems more likely the result of a meteor hitting the Earth than a vehicle from outer space. Of course let us not forget that what may seem in some UFO crash reports as having normal explanations from meteor strikes to things falling from aircraft, hidden behind these cases may indeed be something else. I love that old saying "Don't throw the baby out with the bathwater". As we know, the Governments of this world are more than capable in misguiding the public into believing something else happened in other matters and so it's not without merit that they could do so again with this enigma.

But why do UFOs crash on Earth? Well let's be realistic about things, even us lowly humans have accidents, the NASA space programme for instance with all its millions of dollars pushed into it, still had safety issues to contend with and a number of fatal mishaps occurred. Mankind has sadly seen numerous fatalities in aircraft disasters which sadly still occur to this day. Admittedly some are the result of human error whilst others are the result of faulty design or other problems with the manufacture. A particularly interesting UFO case concerns what was called the Los Angeles Air Raid of February 25th 1942 when a number of unidentified flying objects caused a succession of alerts throughout Southern California. Question were asked at the time about how could U.S. Coastal batteries fire for more than one hour at these UFOs (which were visible to hundreds of witnesses) and yet not hit anything? Although, having said that, it later was uncovered (many many years later through FOIA documents,) that one downed UFO was found off the coast of California and also one in the San Bernardino Mountains. The documents stated that these objects were not of earthly design and in all probability were interplanetary in origin.

Then there is the case of Braxton County West Virginia during a September night in 1952. It initially started with fire ball reports and later turned into something straight out of the Twilight Zone, with monsters and aircraft shooting at a fleet of UFOs. This case received a 'HI' count ratio by the author underneath the title of the incident in the book. The author has carefully looked at the evidence (or what evidence we have) of each case in the book and put them into a category like speedometer which goes from LO to HI (depending on how good or bad the case research is) This is a clever way of showing to the reader on how good or bad the case stands with the information available. Yes a very clever way of doing it Ryan.

Of course with crashes, there follows that if manned there should be bodies, and there are. It's not just Roswell we're talking about here; we're looking at a few other cases of what people have described as 'The Greys'. Small child like bodies being found either inside or outside the crashed Flying Saucer, take for instance the Santa Rosa New Mexico case from 1963. Some bodies were found from a crashed disc and taken to a nearby hospital (which is rare as usually the Military get in there first) Anyway they were taken to hospital oozing brown liquid, X Rays were taken of the 'aliens' and many a puzzled look from those few hospital staff who saw them were in evidence. Needless to say, within an hour the Air Force arrived and took away all the hospital staff notebooks and X rays which were still hanging up soaking wet. Other items were taken away from the hospital ambulance that had taken the bodies away, and of course the bodies were taken away as well.

There are a few British cases contained within the book as well, such as the Cannock Chase incident and the Boscombe Downs case, as well as Rendlesham and a few others. (Including the Isle of Lewis Scottish case) For me though, probably one of the stranger cases is the events which occurred over at Varginha in Brazil during January 1996. Some of the more learned UFOlogists amongst us may know this case particularly well, but for those that don't, well I won't spoil it here by going into it, you'll have to buy the book and find out. But it's a cracker of a case.

The close of the book sees the author again looking at U.S. Government documents in regards to what would be the procedure in telling the public about the reality of these objects. In the past, as the book shows, many U.S. Government departments planted false and very misleading info on true UFO events to take the public attention away from them. An interesting point is raised in regards to 'SHOULD WE' respond to an alien signal from outer space. The reason why 'Should' is stated, is simply because, how do we know that they might be friendly.? They may come here for conquest. No seriously, if we did respond to an alien signal from space and welcomed them aboard as it were, they could be creatures which 'might' see us humans as delicacies. Now think about it, that's not as absurd as it sounds. We humans kill many animals all over planet Earth to curb our hunger who's to say that we may appear a yummy meal to some alien from a distant star system, so I guess there is method in hanging fire in replying to a signal from space.

The author goes further and states that British researcher Timothy Good was told by a NSA (National Security Agency) linguist that an agency (SIGINT) set up to look for 'alien' signals from space, had so far uncovered no less than nine alien groups. It was also stated that a possible receiving point for these signals from space, is either in Nevada or California (see page 232) The state department office of Advanced Technology stated that should there be any real confirmation of alien beings from other worlds, that information should be made freely available to the public, sadly the NSA jumped right in there and stated that this was both 'foolish and dangerous' Again we can see their point from what I've already stated above. We may only be a good meal for them, or alternatively, they may try and force their culture and belief system on our planet totally disrupting our current way of living, now that in itself is scary.

The author states that back in 1968 a chap called Lambros Callimahos wrote a paper discussing what may happen should mankind come in contact with an alien race, in part; this is what he had to say.

"If 'they' discover you, it is an old but hardly invalid rule of thumb "they" are your technological superiors. Human history has shown us time and time again the tragic results of confrontation between a technologically superior civilization and a technologically inferior people. The "Inferior" is usually subject to physical conquest".

The book also looks at SETI and Animal Mutilations which brings up some interesting facts. However the author quite rightly states and I quote,

"SETI has been pursuing for decades. In the words of the X Files, the truth really is out there. However, we may find it not by vainly seeking messages from the stars, but by delving deep into the hidden world of U.S. Intelligence".

Now you don't need to be a rocket scientist to agree with this reviewer on how true that statement is. The author also presents in his closing chapter, some of the noted testimony from some of the early Apollo and Mercury space programme astronauts. For instance the late Gordon Cooper one of the original Mercury astronauts stated in his memoirs that whilst piloting a F-86 Sabrejet, he witnessed a metallic saucer shaped object that could out

manoeuvre the American fighter planes. In the 1950's Gordon managed to capture some film footage of a UFO as it hovered above a dry lake bed. Needless to say, the film was taken by officials to Washington and was never seen again.

All in all, this book by Ryan S Wood adds a lot to the UFOlogical history of the Flying Saucer phenomenon, more so in regards to its content of crashed Flying Saucers. I found it a very stimulating book, easy to read and well presented. Of course Ryan could only work on the facts that he had. Who knows, if further research were undertaken on any of the cases in this book, perhaps we might get a surprise. The thing is of course, is that many, if not all of these cases happened quite some time ago. The witnesses may have died or moved away from the area and are un-contactable. Nevertheless, this book should be in anyone's bookcase, believer or sceptic alike for at the end of the day, a reference book like this on UFO crashes from around the world (and I'm sure there must be more than is contained within this book) is a vital read.

Therefore I strongly recommend this book, make a point of ordering it today, take it from me, you will not be disappointed.

BOOK REVIEW

BEYOND PHOTOGRAPHY (Encounters with orbs, angels and mysterious light forms) by Katie Hall and John Pickering.
 Pub: O Books 2006, Just Hunt Publishing Ltd, Winchester, Hants, £12.99. ISBN 1-90504-790-8

What amazes me is that the authors have produced this very interesting work within 5 years of starting out with their digital cameras, and found a publisher quickly. From what normally transpires "unknown" writers struggle for years to break through and often resort to self-publishing.

"Beyond Photography" gives very comprehensive coverage of the "ORBS" phenomenon with

more than 50 B/W photographs and a colour supplement. It appears to have been mainly written by John Pickering with his photogenic partner, Katie Hall, as the central feature in most of the photographs surrounded by orbs (Are they attracted to her?).

Most of the photography has been produced round the author's home at Brackenbreck, Cumbria, which seems to have been a veritable hotbed for the appearance of phenomena, although there has been peaks and troughs in the arrival of orbs and other strange objects captured by the camera. Pickering implies that the "ORB" phenomenon is worldwide and is derived from non-human origins. He dismisses the usual debunking scenarios rather briefly and thus keeps a positive attitude throughout the book. I was disappointed that there is no actual history of when orbs first appeared (they have definitely existed from the mid-1990s when I picked up many examples on an old 35mm camera, and still do). The book indicates to some extent that the digital camera is a necessity, but this is not so. Of course the digital camera has one great advantage in that a play back of a shot can be done instantly, so if there are orbs present further photos can be fired off immediately without guesswork.

The authors have achieved a number of examples of orbs which are partly concealed behind bushes or furniture indicating that they are at the same distance as the objects in focus and not created by moisture on the lens - in agreement with my findings some years ago. They have also shown that animals can sense the presence as shown in several photographs of the family cat appearing to leap at orbs.

Another unanswered question is whether the authors or their friends can "see" orbs before taking photographs. This claim has come to my notice on several occasions elsewhere and of course would eliminate guesswork in when to photograph. I assume the authors have no instincts for this, but can maximise the number of pictures they take when things seem to be happening.

Pickering goes on to discuss the similarity between orbs and ball lightning and even talks a little about that old favourite, "Foo Fighters". Luminosities which are visible and seen near crop circles inevitably come into the discussion.

In the second half of the work, the authors have amazing pictures of "angels", "fairies", and humanoid outlines which can be identified in a mist, plus a few remarkable light rods. It is not clear whether these manifestations are just coincidental or of great significance. I have several photographs of mists appearing which I was not aware of beforehand, but these do not look like anything in particular.

Pickering sums up the findings by delving into abstract ideas of consciousness and space and time and concludes there is another level of reality impinging on our own. Thankfully the philosophy is quite concise and doesn't waffle too much. What is pleasing is that at the end of each chapter there is a series of one or more "Critical Angles" in which questions are asked and answered in a short, sharp mode often being just "Yes" and "No". Thus if the reader hasn't understood all the detail in a chapter, these neat summaries should clarify the situation very quickly.

I found "Beyond Photography" well written, positive, and objective, and am somewhat envious of the pictures the authors have managed to obtain!
