UFO SIGHTINGS

On Monday, March 10th, at about 11.35pm a "mystery glow" lit up the sky over Guernsey in the Channel Isles.

The brilliant light in the sky was reported by harbour authorities in both the island and neighbouring Jersey, and these stated that the whole area was lit up; it was also mentioned in the Press report that two explosions were heard at about the same time.

Further reports of a "mystery blue light" which appeared over the Vale area placed the time at 12.30 a.m. One witness stated that "all the earth was lit up" for some seconds. This same witness had witnessed a fast-moving green light with a centre point some years ago, and commented that on this earlier occasion jet planes had been despatched to investigate but had reported that the object had been travelling about eight times faster than their speed.

An airport spokesman stated that the cloud base that night was about 200 ft. over the airfield, and 500 ft. over the harbour. The spokesman further commented that at 12.30 the airport searchlights are switched on as a routine check, but that they give off an amber light, not blue or green. Reports from Jersey were more numerous on these sightings. No aircraft were reported in trouble

INHABITED- OR NOT?

We are now well into what may well be the most momentous year in our history. For 1969 should see men on the Moon, a dead lump of matter no doubt, but our nearest neighbour in space none the less. From the bases they will set up there they may well be able to ascertain once and for all whether or not the solar planets close to us are inhabited.

To some the question will seem absurd, for we have been assured by those who purport to be in the know that they are indeed inhabited, and by humans very much like ourselves. Adamski told us so, as did Swedenborg a couple of hundred years before. Even so, there are those, principally in Science, who will have none of it, despite the evidence of later space probes which caused modification of the data then to hand, and the reports via astronauts that our own Earth appears lifeless when viewed from a couple of hundred miles up. Is Earth the "testing planet" where humans gain experience in the lower school of life? With the more advanced races living more amenably on our neighbouring planets? The next few years may go some way to answering this and other tantalizing problems.

CONTACT WITH THE OLD ONES

BY LUCIUS FARISH

(The article below has been kindly submitted by the author and our fellow member, Mr. Lucius Farrish, with the kind permission of Joan Whritenour of SAUCER SCOOP, 34th Ave. North, St. Petersburg, Flo. 33710, USA., and it originally appeared in the Dec. '68 issue of that journal. Thanks again to Lucius, we hope he will keep in touch.)

Some years ago, I noticed several very interesting science fiction stories in issue of various magazines, all of them by the same author. As this author often made references to Charles Fort in his stories, I decided to write to him and see if, perhaps, he had been a member of the Fortean Society. He replied, stating that although he had never joined the Society, he had "always been fascinated by the man's works and (I) feel he's very near the truth in a great part of it." As I mentioned my interest in UFOs and Forteanism in my letter to him, he proceeded to tell me the following story:

"I once knew a man, way back in the 30s (and he was about eighty then, an old sailing boat skipper who had participated in the great grain races around the Horn) who called himself only 'Harmonious'. We used to sit around on the beach and listen while he told us, quietly and without affectation, of his meetings with his astral friends high atop Mt. Shasta (and many years later the first UFOs were sighted right near that spot) and of his many trips throughout this system and others. He was bearded, never seemed to change from one year to the next; a vegetarian, and a gentle soul. His description of the vehicle used for flight very closely resembled certain other descriptions now in common usage—all this long before the huge UFO scare. Harmonious was last seen in the late 50s—and looking exactly as he had thirty years before. Ageless, apparently, and a man curiously untroubled by the opinions of his listeners, who, unanimously labelled him a harmless nut. He never attempted to capitalize on his experiences, unlike certain self-styled contactees with us today."

Needless to say, I was very interested in this story, and fired off another letter to the author, asking for more details on "Harmonious". In his second letter, he gave the requested details, but asked that the material be kept in confidence. However, it is now five years later and I am purposely omitting the author's name, I can see no harm in divulging this (to me) quite interesting story. His second letter contained the following:

"I'll try to recall more of what he (Harmonious) had to say in his own quiet way (the man never tried to force his ideas on anyone—quite the contrary. Unless asked a direct question, he never volunteered information. But he'd answer anything, quickly and frankly, as I recall).

"I do know that he had two manners of speaking. When he talked of beings on other planets, he was often facetious ('Martians') was the most often used expression). However, he was deeply serious whenever he spoke of the 'OLD ONES'. Insofar as the Old Ones were concerned,

his particular friend used a vehicle that, apparently, was a low-slung gondola, without wheels or any visible means of support or propulsion, for that matter. He'd often pick up a clam-shell or half shell, that is, and say the vehicle looked almost like that.

"A low couch, nothing else. No top, or sides, or windshields. When it moved the atmosphere surrounding the vehicle darkened and became opaque-nothing was visible. Also, no feeling of motion, or gravity. Apparently, his friend(an Old One) utilized applied levitation as a propulsive force. This vehicle was used only to pick him up and take him to the domain of the Old Ones. This was far beneath the earth. Usually he entered via a cavern on Mt. Shasta. There are other entrances -Antarctica, the Andes-in fact, look at the so-called 'circle of fire' on a good geological map-and the great faulted areas surrounding the Pacific and you'll approximate the many areas he mentioned as portals to the old people's world.

"These Old Ones have dated back several hundred million years (and yet, taking planet Earth as criterion, there's been time and more than enough time for fifty such races to have risen, achieved godlike eminence-decay, and fall into silence). Often, in his joking manner, Harmonious spoke of the many planets that are around our sun and are still undiscovered. He was quite casual about the surface features of the planets, probably because he never spent much time there-he was always in them, not on them. I get the impression that there may be others, not of the Old People, utilizing these planets; apparently, these others are of little interest to Harmonious (and by extension, his friends, the Old Ones, and are even something of a joke to him (and again, to the Old Ones).

"All the Old Ones are of one race, both here and on the other planets. They carry on intercourse with one another here on earth, the planets, and there various natural satellites (all of which are inhabited underground). They have a great many artificial satellites around the gravitational nodes of all these bodies, which are used I assume, solely for docking facilities for their interplanetary craft. (All this was told us by Harmonious long before WW2-and certainly long before the first UFO outcry following the Mt. Rainier sightings).

..."To extrapolate from Harmonious' stories of the old people; Deep within the core of any planet the temperature would be controllable given an inexhaustible source of power (and knowledge) and such power is inherent in the very force which created this planet... Incidentally, Harmonious anticipated Velikovsky by some years, when he told us of a disaster of unparalleled magnitude which struck the earth several hundred millions of years ago-and which he saw reproduced by a recording device similar to a moving picture projector but unlike it in action: a planetoid approached earth and caused the complete destruction of the existing atmosphere... the only life to survive was that in the depths of the seas-and deep underground.

"If this sort of accident occurs in Nature as a matter of course, one could well understand why an ancient and immensely intelligent race would choose to modify their environment and live far underground on all the planets, manufacturing all their necessities... So, according



to Harmonious, all the planets are inhabited by a long-lived scientifically advanced race, all living deep beneath the surface (at least well down in the crust—here it would be about 35 miles down), all humanoid in appearance, and undoubtedly masters of the Solar System. There may be others living on the surfaces; undoubtedly a younger inferior race (perhaps remnants of other earlier surface races), but far younger than the Old Ones. On this planet we are the surface dwellers; we have a long way to go yet—and when we get there, the Old Ones will have been there first—and long since moved on. * The Old Ones were naked or wore simple loin cloths (We found this amusing).

Considering the foregoing information, is anyone game for a re-reading of Richard Shaver's writings or the books and magazines dealing with the "Allende letters"? Not to mention Jessup's "THE CASE FOR THE UFO", with its comments on the use of "gravitational nodes" by spacecraft. We are all fairly sure that there is someone "out there". Is there also someone "down there"?

MYSTERIOUS VISITOR FROM SPACE?

"Australian Thinks He Has Found the Footprints Of A Being From Another Planet"

Twenty-eight-year-old Australian bulldozer driver Sydney Ford has found some footprints which he thinks are the gigantic tracks of a being from another planet. BLACK LIGHT

A REPORT FROM DOWN UNDER

(The following has been sent to COS-MOS by Mr.P.Livingston, of 80,Gulf View Rd.Christies Beach, S.Australia)

I should like to relate a sighting that took place around July,1965, about six miles from my home.The report never appeared in the Press, and we have since carried out further investigations to no avail.Most UFO reports have a much of the sameness about them, though this one had something unique about it, for this area,anyway.

The place name is Clarendon,about a mile from Happy Valley reservoir due south of Adelaide. The person concerned is a fruit farmer, a strong Roman Catholic, but not a fanatic- I mention this regarding the truth of his statement. The time was about 9.45 p.m.;he'd left his house to move about a dozen sprinklers on his orchard, carrying a torch whose batteries he tells me badly needed changing; in other words he had a pretty feeble light.


About 400 yds. from his house,(the rest of the family were out) he became conscious of a dark shadow in front of him. Thinking he'd strayed from the path and was standing by a large gum tree which stands in his orchard he shone his torch towards the shadow. He saw what he describes as a beam of black light about six feet across, the edges showing up quite clearly in the torch light. Looking upward he saw eight or nine orange coloured lights about 5000 ft up; he thinks 5000 ft. but is willing to accept the height as probably wrong-it is extremely difficult to estimate height in daytime let alone at night. Thinking at first it was an aircraft he watched it, but as the object never moved he realized it was something strange, and in his own

words, that although he'd seen⁵ action in the Middle East in WW2, he'd never felt as frightened as then, and he quickly returned to the house.

We checked the area in case he'd seen car lights from the surrounding hills, but this was impossible; no aircraft were due or had taken off at this time. What struck me was his saying he'd shone his torch up the beam, and that it clearly showed the edges. His torch,in his own words, had only a feeble light. I started thinking of absorption of light and power, his sprinkler system, the nearness of the big reservoir and came up with a couple of ideas which wouldn't work using normal physics. 6 VOICES FROM

Starting here—the amazing story

When I first heard of flying saucers in 1947, I dismissed them entirely as a product of American post-war neurosis. It was not until October 1956, when, for a lark, I bought Adamski's second book, "Inside the Space Ships", that I really began to take the matter seriously. Either Adamski's story was true or it was not. So there and then I made up my mind to discover the truth for myself, even if it killed me. It has not done yet.

Fantastic though it may sound, it seems that the "space people" (if such there be) were waiting for me. For a few weeks after having made this decision, I had a strong hunch to walk up the top of Sir William Hill. This is along Moorland Road, climbing up to an altitude of 1,400 ft. overlooking the Derwent Valley, in my own village of Grindleford, some ten miles south-west of Sheffield. On my way down, I was rewarded by seeing a slow pulsating light altering from dark red to brilliant magnesium white, which could not be explained. And a few weeks after, when walking down the same hill, I was "buzzed" by a brilliant object which hovered straight in front of me, switching over from white to red, then disappearing. These two experiences convinced me, not only that flying saucers existed, but that the intelligences behind them knew quite a bit about me.

During the summer of 1957, there were many sightings in the Sheffield area, some of them reported by me in "Flying Saucer Review" and in September I heard a large number of musical notes, apparently produced by invisible flying objects. Sometimes they whizzed through the air

at great speed. At other times they paced me as I was walking along a country road, and at other times they played scraps of melody, somewhat unrhythmic, but with beautiful bell-like tones. Being a musician, I could identify them by the notes they produced. And once, while I was playing a recorder solo in the key of C before an audience of 300 schoolchildren, one of these objects, steadily emitting the note of C sharp, was heard, not only by myself but by my fellow artists, and several members of the teaching staff as well. Then, on the same day, whilst walking to another school, apparently the same object paced us all the way, very much to my delight, though it scared the daylight out of the lady soprano who was with me. Later, I heard of some people in County Ross common in Eire hearing similar sounds. So they were not noises in my head!

On November 24th (1957), I had the idea of trying to record one of these songs. Placing the microphone of my Grundig machine on the outer sill of my bed sitting room window, I switched on, ran downstairs, and stood in front of out gate. After a few minutes I was rewarded with a peculiar, penetrating, whistling sound, apparently coming from behind the ash tree on the other side of our lane. Immediately, I ran indoors and rewound the tape, fully expecting there to be nothing on it. But, to my intense relief, there was the sound, as clear as a bell. I noticed a peculiar rising, double fundamental note, quite alien to any

sound I had heard on earth. That was my first recording of a sound believed to emanate from outer space and can be studied by anyone who wishes to listen to it.

Over the Christmas holiday, I picked up several sounds that were hard to explain, that provided no definite evidence. It was not until February, 1958, after a very severe blizzard, that a real breakthrough occurred. I recorded several dulcimer-like bleeping sounds, in between which appeared the voice of a small girl shouting "Howdy!" This pointed to the possibility that whoever the young lady was, she had learned her English in the States!

The next breakthrough occurred on March 21st, round about midday. It consisted of a mechanically produced computer-voice, saying faintly but clearly and definitely, "Ship is real, people," against a background of clicking, resembling the noise of a typewriter. This was the first of a very few terse messages I have received. I took it to mean that the space ships are real and are piloted by people.

COMET WILL BRING STORMS

From a "Sunday Express" report

World-wide storms and earthquakes are forecast for the summer between June and September as a comet flies close to the earth. This statement was made by Mr. Allen Hencher of Dagenham, Essex, a GPO telephonist whose predictions were checked by independent survey and found very accurate. The "Evening Standard" set up a special bureau in 1967 to check Hencher's premonitions, which have included air disasters.

This is a good place to pause and explain how the majority of my recordings have been taken. All I do is to place the microphone on the outer sill of my bed sitting room (about twelve feet from the ground), close the sash, and switch on my machine. On no occasion has the recorder been connected to my radio, which is never on at the time of recording. The signals are never heard at the time of reception but detected only on play-back. The best time for recording I have found is about 9 p.m.-don't ask me why. (To be continued in next issue)
