

Well, not exactly, for the originator of the Men in Black (MIB) saga seems to have been Al.K.Bender, the man whose book of supposedly terrifying experiences led him to wind up his ufo activities and refuse to discuss the subject ever again with anyone-or did it? For lo! Al has popped up again, bounced back into the UFO Scene as "Western Editor" for-guess who? His old buddy and publisher Gray Barker.

Keel is the most prolific of ufo writers, and a good one, there's no denying that, writing is his profession. It's difficult to pick up a copy of a ufo journal (among the leading ones) without finding a Keel piece within. His writings range from some fascinating theories on the origin of ufos to the latest pot-boiling reports and conjecture regarding those sinister black-suited aliens who, according to Keel, are terrorizing not only close contactees but writers, TV producers, researchers, and even (yes!) shooting at a newsman in a laundromat.

Connected with the above are the organizations which have allegedly collapsed because of MIB harrassment leading personalities in the field who have bowed out of the scene altogether. These events CAN be ascribed to perfectly natural causes by those of us who have had no personal experience of them. Plenty of ufo fans have changed their hobbies or lost interest, perhaps thru frustration. And, after all, it was Leonard Cramp who said: 'One spends hours over the years discussing aspects of this and that subjects and always you are left with the feeling-well, where has it got us, do we know any more?'

Out of the dozens, hundreds, of people either writing about ufos or claiming contacts, some six of the better-known have died during the past few years. Inevitably, Mr. Keel and others suggest some possible sinister significance in this. With professional skill such writers stir the fear and imagination of their readers, and, judging by the letter columns of Gray Barker's SAUCER NEWS (which occupy most of 12 pages), the ufo readership in USA is of a low enough ilk to swallow it all, however, sensational.

The following report from Arthur Shuttlewood has, we are fully aware, already been printed in several UFO Journals. It was, however, pointed out to us that as Arthur had named the people concerned, their own story should be obtained. This we have done, and we are here pleased to print the experiences of Chris Troubridge and Robert Coates in their own words. As is not unusual with UFO reports, the story from Arthur, and that from Chris and Robert evinces some differences in detail. In the main, though, the stories tally, and whilst we would not claim that Chris definitely met an extra-terrestrial, we certainly feel something unusual occurred; whether hoax, landing or ???-we leave to your own good judgement, - or in Arthur's own words "accept or reject, - that is your prerogative".

One point should be made - namely that Chris and Robert are familiar with the night sky - they gave me ample proof of this; when therefore they claim to have seen two unusual objects or lights in the sky, I would consider the odds to be very much on those lights being unusual and behaving in a manner considerably out of the ordinary.

Hoaxes by third parties, particularly so far as the figure is concerned obviously cannot be entirely eliminated, and should this be one we can only say we feel it to be in very bad taste and certainly a disservice to the study of Ufology. Here then, are the stories for you to judge.

LANDING AT KIDNAPPER'S HOLE

-Arthur Shuttlewood-

Thirteen people were in our skywatching party at Cradle Hill, Warminster, on the evening of Wednesday, August 27th, 1969. An unlucky number? Not so far as dramatic UFO sightings and a landing were concerned, on this auspicious occasion, anyway! Accept or reject the following - that is your prerogative:-

My team mates, Bob Strong and Sybil Champion, left the hill at 9.30 p.m., after we had been observing for about an hour. They went off to Starr Hill, midway between Battlesbury and Scratchbury, other well known viewing peaks locally. The remaining 11 were:

Ex-naval commander's wife Mrs. Kathleen Bent; her friend Mrs. Eileen Keck, of Winchester; Mr. Ian Gowan and his wife Kathryn, Bournemouth; American Mrs. Gwen Smith, Seattle; Mr. Christopher Trubridge, Gosport; his friend Mr. Robert Coates, Yorkshire; an American-speaking visitor who calls himself Diophantes, from Sirius 6 (his own claim, not mine); Mr. Julian Butler, Mr. John Alford and myself, all of Warminster.

At 10.10 p.m. the attention of several pairs of eyes was caught by what Mr. Butler described as 'a burning bush,' about 600 yards south-west of our vantage point on Cradle Hill. It is a little right of the West-Wilts Golf Clubhouse and a few hundred yards short of it, at a point near a long and straggling hedgerow.

Frankly, I suspected it was rubble being burnt by the farmer, Mr. Geoffrey Gale (it is his land); but we all commented how strange that this circular flame should suddenly erupt without warning, no smouldering or smoke noticed prior to this by our keen-eyed group. Chris and Bob immediately tore across the intervening land. Others, self included,

climbed the white gate and followed at a more leisurely pace. (Perhaps because we were older?)

The burning effect 'died' on the ground and we were instantly aware of a large orange ellipsoid, hanging stationary over the top of the lighted clubhouse at low altitude - we estimated somewhere around 100 feet at most. It was immobile for a good three minutes, according to my watch. John said: 'It is far too big and brilliant for Mars, although it's the same colour.' Julian said: 'No - Mars is away to the left, higher and over Cop Heap.'

There was no lingering doubt when the object, increasing radiance, started to move to south-east, across Cop Heap and away over the shoulder of Battlesbury towards Starr Hill. It was huge! It moved slowly, sedately throwing off a bright and fitful halo around the main body of the craft.

We had now picked out a second similar shaped object, much higher than the first, this smaller because of this factor and a dull mat white in hue. It was keeping pace with the bright orange UFO, trailing it. But our attention was abruptly dragged from the visual treat...

I had sped back to the central body of watchers, eager that one in particular - she is over 80 years of age, yet was so thrilled - should see the smaller UFO too. Pointing this out to her (the others had spotted it), I heard cries coming from the field - and tearing towards us; ashen-faced, were Chris and Robert.

They drank hot coffee to recover from obvious shock and shattered composure. Then they blurted out an amazing story. When they reached Kidnapper's Hole, where the hedge ends, they saw the flame or 'burning bush' peter out; and in its place was a tall figure, dressed in tight-fitting black suit that had a sheen reflected in their torchlight. A gold-coloured 'sash' or 'bandolier' (the youths' terms) was around its neck and shoulder.

Bob is 6 ft. 1 in. tall. He thought the figure to be a good foot taller than he. Chris confirmed this. Long dark hair, bright eyes - and rather 'feminine' features, the lads agreed. The figure did not move - but they, overcome by fear, could not approach nearer than about 30 yards from it. Courage and nerves failing, they ran back to the hilltop.

The two were closely questioned by the rest of the watchers while I made my way across the field. I had a torch and was beaming a friendly message in morse code in front of me, to relieve any apprehension on the part of our 'visitor.' My knees were knocking, too, I admit, yet one can never reach understanding with fear triumphing over genuine love and concern for all others...

Nothing was visible of the figure from then on. Chris, Bob, Julian and John revisited the spot near Kidnapper's Hole where it had stood: they all saw the hedgerow, clubhouse, two trees on the skyline; none smelled smoke or ashes.

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CHRIS TRUBRIDGE & ROBERT COATES STORY

".....there were thirteen of us on the hill," said Chris Trubridge, "and at about 10.10 p.m. a bright light like a bush burning was seen in the direction of the West Wilts Golf Club-house in the spot known as 'Kidnapper's Hole', - this was first noticed by Arthur Shuttlewood and I said to him 'let's go over and see'; Arthur was not all that keen as most of the group were elderly and it meant crossing a ploughed field, so Bob and I ran on in front."

The light petered out when the two were about half-way (two to three hundred yards) from it and Robert Coates tells us "When we had got half-way and the 'burning bush' had petered out, we noticed this light in the sky above and in the same line of sight as the Golf House". Both agreed it was an orangy colour, - the same as Mars, which at first they thought it was, until it was realised that Mars was away over to the left. Chris continued:

"..... Mr. Shuttlewood had gone back to let the others know about the 'craft' in the sky which was joined by a second craft, but Bob and I carried on to this particular place where the 'burning bush' first appeared, - I was the only person who saw the 'humanoid', and the clothing was in fact reflected not by torchlight, but in the moonlight, - there was almost a full moon that night. Bob was some way behind. The figure had something like a gold sash round the neck and chest. The hair seemed to be on the fair side though it was difficult to tell..." Between the 'burning bush' going out and the figure appearing, both Chris and Bob's attention was distracted by the light over the Golf House, - this gradually moved and when it went 'into the moonshine' Chris's attention was brought back to the ground which was when he saw the figure, - there was a short time lapse between the 'burning bush' going out and the figure appearing. Chris goes on to say that the red light moved over Cop Heap, round in relation to Lords Hill and disappeared over Battlesbury Hill. As it was over Cop Heap a second and smaller light appeared above and behind the red one, keeping pace with it till they disappeared in the direction of Stonehenge.

But to return to the figure: Chris said "I was about 100 feet away from the figure when I saw it, - there was no movement except that as I watched it the figure raised its right hand." Bob here raised the point as to whether it might have been to shield its eyes from torchlight, - he was carrying the torch, which had rather a weak battery, was some way behind Chris and did not himself see the figure (he was looking at the red UFO). Chris definitely stated, however, that it was not a movement of this sort and stressed again that what he saw was by moonlight not torchlight.

Chris went on ".....then I felt scared, turned and ran, and cannoned into Bob, saying 'Lets get the hell out of here'. Bob, of course, did not have the slightest idea of what he was supposed to be running from, but nevertheless ran back over the ploughed field with me to the rest of the party where we were both questioned and given hot coffee."

Chris was certain in his own mind that the figure was considerably <sup>5</sup> taller than Bob who is 6'1", - he also felt certain that it was a male figure, though he also felt it was rather on the effeminate side. It had a largish face with rather tapering features, not a very big jaw; the figure showed up well in the moonlight. The following day, both checked the hedgerows in the vicinity to see if any had peculiar shapes which might involuntarily have been mistaken for a figure, but there were none, and Chris says that he is quite sure he definitely did not see an ordinary person, - the figure was wearing a dark one-piece garment, tight fitting, something like a diver's but more of silkish material.

An interesting point is that there were several people camping out on The Copse with scientific equipment including a Geiger Counter, who asked to be shown the spot where the figure appeared. Whilst the Geiger Counter worked normally elsewhere, the reverse of what might perhaps have been expected occurred at the spot where the figure had been seen, - the Geiger Counter 'packed up' and registered nothing! This was tested several times to make sure the Counter itself was not at fault but with the same result.

To return to the UFOs, - the orange one did not really 'register' until it started moving, when Bob flashed at it with his torch and got the definite impression it began to come toward them. When he looked at it through binoculars he said it 'seemed to grow in size, come forward, tilt and then stop before it moved off again, but as it tilted there seemed to be orange lines of light going backwards from the sides'

When first seen, the light of this UFO was comparable to that of Mars though perhaps a little brighter, this brightness later increasing considerably.

Two afterthoughts on the sightings: should anyone consider the star Antares, - the name means 'rival of Mars' as a likely culprit, it would seem rather unlikely, to say the least, that this would journey over to the South-east and disappear behind Battlesbury Hill!

A sighting of a white UFO was believed to have been made at Stonehenge by members of CUF OSS at 9.50 p.m. on the same night, though this was travelling in a direction which would take it away from Warminster.

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
# UFO SUB?

We publish here just some of the very interesting experiences of Mr. A. G. Mobey, who has kindly submitted them with a sketch from which the COS-MOS drawings were made. The following relates to a craft which may well be the same reported in other publications which include positive sightings of unidentified submarine-type vessels seen at sea. Mr. Mobey has also had remarkable "subjective" experiences in which more "conventional" ufos and their occupants were seen. These may be detailed in another issue of COS-MOS.

The first experience concerning this craft occurred during November, 1968, I cannot give the exact date as I normally do not make any subsequent detailed notes, the experience being sufficiently real to make this unnecessary. (What follows is an out-of-the-body experience.)

I became conscious in what appeared to be a centre access corridor of a submarine. This apparently was so because the metal wall facing was slightly concave and there were service pipes of various diameters fixed to the corridor walls and traversing the length of the corridor. There also were control valves on some of these pipes. The corridor floor was metal and my impression of its width was some 12-14 ft. I was greeted pleasantly by two men, who were dressed in some kind of two-piece suiting of neutral colour (grey if anything). The men were bare-headed, as were all the men I later saw. I did not recognize them, but to me they were normal people.

The two men formed on either side of me, slightly to my rear so I could see about me, and we turned left and walked down the corridor. As we walked some 30 or 40 feet, perhaps more, I passed other men



similarly dressed who were standing discreetly at intervals, as if temporarily away from a station for the purpose of my seeing them and their seeing me. The corridor extended right as well as left, but we turned left. After 3P-40ft. we came to the corridor's end, facing a metal wall. Here, facing me, I noticed another man quite different from the rest. He was over 6 ft. tall, slim and all white in some way, even to his clothes and hair; he also appeared to be shining and slightly translucent. My impression was that of a Spiritual being.

My two companions now took me by the elbows as a square section of the floor sank beneath us. It was a lift as on aircraft carriers. We came to rest facing two corridors, one straight ahead, the other to the left with a kind of dog-leg curve in it. I could see some kind of machines in this corridor, and being intrigued, began to walk towards them. But after a few feet the experience terminated.

Recapping, I seemed to have been given a brief guided tour in some large, metal, cylindrical shaped vehicle with a considerable civilian crew and a commander who was entirely different from them. A few days later I had a clairvoyant type experience. I saw in the distance as if in a void at some 45° a line of men joined by linked arms—some three or four dozen of them, all in neutral suiting and bare-headed. In the centre was a taller man in white whose outline shimmered. I thought—"This must be the crew of that submarine thing, and the centre one is the commander", when the whole line of them rushed down upon me through the air and swooped over my head. This made me jump, and as they came I received a friendly, amused impression as if they were conveying, "Here we all are again and we bet this will make you jump!"

Some time later I experienced a further out-of-the-body happening. I found myself walking down what appeared to be an average suburban-type street. The road was wide and the houses had good gardens. It was daylight and the sky was clear. In the sky, broadside on at what appeared to be an altitude of 200 ft. and 2-300 yds. distance I saw what can only be described as a sophisticated submarine (Mr. Mobey's description follows and his sketch is the basis of our drawing). This large, metal very real vehicle, dark grey to black in colour was moving slowly thru the air to my right. Some sort of classification letter was painted in white on the tower, and I was close enough to discern that the paint was peeling a little. I watched this vehicle move to my right until its outline became less solid, it looked ethereal-ghostly in fact. My thoughts were that this machine could obviously fly thru air and water.

You can imagine how astonished I was to read reference to this kind of vehicle in Weekend magazine. Fortunately I wrote about these experiences to two acquaintances before seeing this feature.



Odessa, Washington, USA. 18/1/68



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SOME LIGHT ON THE UFOs

In early March, 1958, Marcio Goncalves and companions were being chased by a ufo along the Ponta Poran Road near the frontier of Paraguay. Suddenly the object dived at high speed, not towards the jeep which Marcio was driving, but towards the top of a hill well ahead of the vehicle. It descended over the hill, stopping on the ground in the middle of the road blocking their way. Marcio Goncalves, though panic-stricken, kept going. The jeep started up the hill with everyone waiting for the inevitable crash. As the jeep climbed the hill its headlights were gradually raised until the beams of light shone directly on the ufo. To everyone's amazement, the object began to wobble violently, then shot straight up into the air as though running away. The jeep was followed for a short time afterwards by the ufo, but from a distance, after which it vanished into the darkness.

On the night of December 21st, 1957, on the same road with the same driver but different companions, two ufos followed the jeep. Alternately, one object would go ahead of the jeep and shine a brilliant light on its occupants while the other followed closely behind apparently observing them. Twice during this chase the jeep pulled up; the reaction of the ufos in each case was instantaneous. Both diving at high speed, one would hover throwing a beam of light on the ground, while the other would approach the illuminated spot. It did not land but appeared to hover motionless above the ground. Its brilliance would decrease.

What can be made of the above reports? The inference I would like to put forward is that ufos do not like beams of light shone on them and on occasions try to duplicate the effects on the vehicles they chase. There seems to be a fair amount of evidence to support this view for the above two cases are by no means isolated ones.

For further examples. On the night of 3rd October, 1958, south-bound train No. 91 en route from Monon, Indiana, to Indianapolis, was under observance by four ufos, Ed Robinson, the conductor, ran into the caboose and grabbed a powerful five-cell sealed beam flashlight. He switched the light on and threw the beam at the ufos. To use his own words, "As soon as the light hit them they jumped sideways out of its beam. When they came back over the tracks I gave them another shot of that light and this time they scattered. I had a feeling that they didn't like it at all. After we shined the light on them that second time they didn't come in close any more."

In September, 1965, on the National Road between Silverton and Bronkhorstspuit, South Africa, Constables Koos de Klerk and John Lockem in a patrol car came upon a saucer-shaped ufo in the centre of the road surrounded by a sea of flames. Constable de Klerk said it was

copper-coloured and shone. It was clearly visible in their headlights. "For a few seconds it stood on the road and then faster than I had ever seen in my life it shot straight up and vanished in a NW direction." It transpired later in an interview that the patrol car's engine had stalled when they came across the object blocking their way.

B.E.Parham of Wellford, South Carolina, after his car had been chased by a ufo along Highway 59, told federal authorities that his car engine had faded and that he had the impression that the ufo was curious about his headlights. In the ufo car-chase incidents the ufo will be very careful to keep clear of the headlight beams while manouvering about the car. If hovering or resting on the roadway when a car approaches it, the ufo will either stall the car's engine and cut the headlights, or take off within a few seconds. There is an exception to this and that is if the ufo is resting on the roadway with its power unit off it does not seem to care one way or the other if headlight beams hit it or not. All this evidence seems to point to the fact that in some way beams of light interfere with its motivation.

A suggestion has been put forward by some researchers that the eyesight of ufo entities is affected by light, causing the erratic behaviour of ufos noted on occasions. Indeed, if you study some of the contactee reports the eyes of the various entities are often reported as large suggesting that the home of these saucer occupants has considerably less light than the earth has. Yet I cannot reconcile myself to believing that it is this affliction to light which causes the ufo pilots to be so wary of light beams. The saucer is a very sophisticated machine and surely nobody is going to fly such a machine in a hostile atmosphere without the instrumentation to overcome poor eyesight. The answer lies, I think, that in some way beams of light interfere with the power source of ufos.

Before proceeding it must be realised that the following is pure speculation but based upon theoretical research into gravitation from relative principles by which it is possible for direct transfer of electromagnetic waves(for example, light) into mechanical force. A rough analogy of this is that some two years ago in the USA a model helicopter with a six-foot vane span was kept airborne some sixteen hours by the transfer of energy to its small motor by micro wave transmission. Now if we assume that the ufo is using electromagnetic radiation as a power source, a sudden burst of strong light shining upon it would be, again using a very rough analogy, the same as pulling the choke out, or jamming your foot hard down on the accelerator of your car-it would become unstable or erratic, until corrected. During daytime, the ufo pilot would of course have made allowances for the strong light, and the craft would be stable unless flying into an area of strong radiation, when some

erratic behaviour would occur until corrected. But at night, especially with the ufo near the ground, the result could well prove fatal to the ufo and its occupants, for not only does the pilot have to contend with the light source, he has no way of knowing when that same source will be switched off, so he has a double danger to contend with. If this be so, it's no small wonder that the ufo is so wary of light beams.

The point could be raised here that the ufo would be very interested in all major power sources and the limit of those sources radiation for their own safety. As I have said previously, this is all pure speculation but I hope it will give the reader some food for thought.

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HANDSOME UFONAUTS in S.America

14. June 1968 : A Catholic peasant family named Fernandez, living in Mar del Plate reported that their home was visited by two unusual individuals, tall and slim, dressed in tight green, fluorescent, protective suits. They were polite and good-natured. On the same day a nineteen-yr-old girl, Maria Elena Pretzel, told of a meeting in Villa Carlos Paz with some individuals who were very handsome, about 6'6" tall and wearing a blue, gleaming suit. A 15-yr-old boy Oscar Iriari, in Olavarria, met some tall green-clothed beings with staring gaze and without eyebrows who alighted from a flying saucer. They gave him a note on which in Spanish he was invited to visit other planets. The invitation was not accepted by Iriari who instead handed it to the Police.

Five witnesses saw a ufo land some 400 yds. from their house, the red light from the object being strong enough to illumine the rooms via cracks in doors and windows. Two occupants descended from the hovering ufo, being some 6'6" tall, dressed in white belted overalls having broad faces, long hair and "looking like saints". The ufo crewmen were white men with large bare feet and long hands. They walked stiffly without bending their knees.

Three more beings then appeared who were of smaller stature, being about 4'8" tall, wearing chestnut brown overalls, with long hair and white skin. They walked quickly being shod in tiny boots but remained close to the ufo. The two larger men walked to an iron fence, arriving by a drainage ditch then retraced their footsteps. A second time they approached by a different route, only to return

to the ufo once more. They then set off again, crossed the ditch via a bridge, found a gate in the iron fence, opened it, closed it and continued towards the house. By now the house owner and foreman of his estate had emerged and lay flat on their bellies beneath some palm trees. The remaining witnesses, the owner's family, remained in the house. The house dogs remained strangely quiet. Noting this, the foreman, being armed, decided to confront the ufonauts, but his master made him stay quiet.

Now the wife of the owner opened the door of the house and shouted to her husband to come inside, at which point the ufonauts stopped. This happened several times during their approach, until they turned round and went back to their craft, whereupon all the crew entered the disc which took off slowly with a rotating motion.

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AIR FORCE HUNT FOR SAUCERS: When the order, "Scramble" goes out to jet fighter pilots of the Spanish Air Force these days there is a good chance it means a search for flying saucers. For Spain is determined to find out why so many mystery flying objects have been reported. In a communique this weekend the air ministry said that such reports should be made immediately to the nearest Air Force station. The communique came 48 hours after a chemist, Antonio Sanz, claimed that a flying object followed his car as he drove home to Duenas, 150 miles north of Madrid. Most spectacular sighting was in September when thousands of people in Madrid saw a bright object passing across the sky. Air Force jet fighters set off in pursuit. One pilot climbed to 50,000 ft. but reported that the mystery object was still high above him. His fuel was running low, and he returned. The "flying saucer" got away.

Sydney: Scores of people reported sighting an unidentified flying object west of Sydney tonight. All descriptions tallied—the object was flat, round, white and 800 to 1000 ft. high. "It's uncanny—I've never seen anything like it," said Mrs. L. Long, of Parramatta. The object was rotating in a half-mile radius and moving slightly to south-east in the Parramatta area," she said.

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THAT SPACE LANGUAGE: The following letter has been received from the Editor of Link-Up and Awareness, Jimmy Goddard.

Dear Mr. Blandford,

I was reading through the last issue of Cos-mos journal again, and noticed that in the Philip Rodgers article there seem to be possible translations of some of the unknown words on the tapes.

Mr. Rodgers does not mention it in the article, but I believe "Ya-ba-huseta" has been translated as "We greet you with love". I cannot remember the source of the translation now, but if true it is possible that, breaking the sentence down, "Ya" is the subject pronoun "We", "ba" (or is it "va"?) is the object pronoun "you", and "huseta" is part of the verb "to greet with love". This is not necessarily so, but seems fairly logical.

Because of the "hallelujah" I believe "Nyanna-poddo" has been translated as "God be praised". This is interesting, because after hearing this translation I happened, quite by chance, to be reading a Buddhist magazine with an article by someone named "Nyanaponika". This word was so similar that I enquired its meaning, and was told that the first part (presumably "Nyana") meant "knowledge, intelligence, insight". Therefore, I think it possible that "Nyanna" means

"God" in the sentence.

With this it may be possible to translate "Ya-va-nyanna-donnava". It would be tempting to believe the word "donnava" was part of the verb "to give"; if so we would have "We give you God". What would be meant by that statement, I have no idea.

I thought you might be interested in these things; of course, I may be completely on the wrong track, but it is interesting to speculate.

P.S. I believe "Nyanaponika" was from the Pali language.

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Comment: Yes indeed, there seems a marked similarity. We will try and obtain some comment from Mr. Rodgers.

TAILED FOR 28 MILES

So a motorist claimed in the following report which appeared in the Advertiser in Australia and was sent us by Mr. Livingston;;; "When a stranger knocks at your hotel room door at 4.30 am. and asks you to view a ufo-what do you do? You humour him-he could be dangerous. So, this is what Adelaide man Mr. D. V. Martlew did when it happened to him. He's with the Public Builders Dept., working near Cowell, and staying in the Commercial Hotel at Cowell. Reading in bed at 4.30 am on Saturday, he was disturbed by a man who knocked on the door and urged him to come and see something in the sky. Which is what Mr. Martlew did. He said he saw what appeared to be a big ball of bright white light, stationary, and on an angle of about 30 degrees. He watched it for about 10 minutes, then he went to tell the others in the hotel, but no one wanted to get out of bed. The motorist who called him was still shaking. He claimed that the ufo had followed him for 28 miles. He'd spotted a light in the Cowell Hotel and called Mr. Martlew to reassure himself that he WAS seeing things.

Also in May this year, several truck drivers in Perth reported being tailed by a ufo for up to 120 miles. One driver stated that the object was diamond-shaped with a band of lights around it. Size was about 30-40 ft. and the incident occurred between 3-4 am.


## the man from TAU CETI

Meanwhile, back in "Scientific Circles", research comes to a grinding halt. Somewhere out in the Arizona desert Hiram J. Contactee reports meeting extraterrestrial travellers. How can intelligent progress be made? Hiram is holding up the solution to the UFO problem. His treacherous ways are being linked to every known serious research organization. The fate of UFOlogy hangs by a thread.

Sound familiar - well, it almost could. Many otherwise rational investigators tend to throw all who fit the stereotyped definition of "contactee" into one pot. Every poor soul who happens to have the misfortune of running into a humanoid is almost automatically tossed into this category. One last thought. If you happen to make contact with some other world intelligence, what would you do? You're ridiculed, branded a "contactee" and your name isn't mentioned in mixed company. You get an offer to make a few bucks with a book. Would YOU take it?

TORONTO WOMAN  
HAS "SPACE CONTACT"

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Prior to July 1968 I had no interest in or knowledge of UFOs, never read a book of them, and was unaware there were any books on them. Also, I do not read science fiction, I prefer Gothic mysteries. So my initial contact was a shock. It took me about three weeks to realise what had happened. Having always been "psychic", astral trips are not new to me, but this one was unlike any of them.

A barren terrain (seen many times since) - what appeared to be (and is) a military base...people in space suits (either thin atmosphere or no atmosphere) all busy around the place. I was introduced to one who appeared to be an officer of some kind... had a long conversation about ethics, politics, religion etc. I became aware that my physical body back here was being worked over by some kind of ray...became physically awake and it was so. This ray centered in my head. I could even hear it. For several nights about the same time this ray came. The third night a voice came with it telling me not to fight it but to relax and learn how to use the power it brought. The next night both voice and vision came...my intellectual friend I met on the trip. He has been my contact since.

We are very close friends. He has shown me the beauty and wonder of the universe. Along with spacecraft, land vehicles, their uniforms, civilian clothes, gadgets, the insides of large spaceships with wall panels full of instruments controls, dials etc.

He also got me to study physics and astronomy so I would understand what he was talking about. He even tested me on this and still does sometimes.

One important rig which I nicknamed the "Mind Machine", looks like a weird TV set. This electronic marvel can be used to contact, also "pick up" minds of both intelligent and primitive life forms. One of my contact's jobs is to use this rig to locate life in space. By this instrument he can tell what type of life is on a given planet. Also this rig can "process" (his words) minds and can produce "mind-pictures" (my words). These show what type of mental make-up or personality, etc. a life form has. I don't know how it works and don't pretend to know. These people have discovered how to manipulate thoughtwaves. I could describe this more but there are other things.

This rig was used on me till I was used to communicating with my contact by ordinary telepathy. Whatever he is doing while he is contacting me or just thinking about me unconsciously, I see him doing it. I see him working, writing and studying our languages. One time I saw him cut his finger while using tools. Another time I saw him washing his hair which they wear quite long. He also sees me this way.

He puts on his radio or record player and lets me listen to their music. Some of it is beautiful. One piece is the most beautiful unearthly thing I ever heard. It is a sort of short symphony of a spaceship soaring into space and all the beauty of space. I have heard this several times and have asked him to play it for me. They also have a type of jazz all their own.

Although much of this contact is personal, not all of it is so pleasant. He tells me there are two groups in his world or part of the universe, something like the Commies and Free world here. One group are cold-blooded fanatics with all the advantages of a superior science and technology to help them. They have no sympathetic regard for us or anyone else. The other group are the "good guys" and are the opposite. These two groups are not just one or two races, but are composed of individuals from all their races, as are our own groups.

He has shown me aerial photographs taken of North American cities. Both sides have the Mind Machine. The implications of this where planet Earth is concerned is obvious.

I believe they have a base in our solar system but I believe they originate elsewhere in our galaxy. Maybe outside our galaxy. They only tell me what they figure I ought to know.

My contact and his immediate associates appear to be a research team. At first they showed great interest in our flora and fauna, but they have other interests which I am not sure about. I think in general they are interested in all forms of life and what makes it tick.

I believe his people use telepaths and ESP-ers for special jobs, like his.

I have also heard many times their language, some words of which I have written down. Also I've seen their writings or printing. I have discovered both language and writings are closely related to the language and writing of ancient MU. The writing is very similar to the heirarchical alphabet of MU. I was led to this.

My contact has black hair; white-golden skin; long, slightly slanting eyes which sometimes look darker, sometimes lighter. Also their eyes can alter and send out light rays. On him it is very attractive. On his superior officer it is scary! A lady scientist at the research center has brown hair, very slanting eyes. It is not always possible to tell the exact color of their eyes. The slant is different to our own Oriental slant. Their eyes are bigger. They are of average Earth height, 5'6" to 6'. My contact is about 5'8". I am 5'2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and he is taller than me.

I am awake when he talks to me or shows me things. We talk any time of the day or night, but it is easier in the middle of the night when things are quiet. The visions, etc. I receive at night when I can close my eyes. Also sometimes in the daytime if I can lay down. I have also met him several times on astral trips since the first one. Once he came right to my apartment. He is a whiz on this type of stuff. This has been a brief resume of events.

- 3(c) The administration of the Society shall be vested in the National Executive Committee, which shall consist of the Director, two Co-Directors and not more than four other members in good standing.
- 3(d) The Director shall hold the position of Chairman of the Committee. The Co-Directors between them shall hold and administer the positions of Vice-Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer of the Society, such positions to be determined by the Committee and notified to the membership via the Journal. Co-Directors shall be elected for a period of two years: ordinary Committee members for a period of one year.
- 5(a) The Annual General Meeting shall be convened in London by the Committee in the autumn of each year.
- (b) An Ordinary General Meeting may be convened by the Committee at its discretion.
- (c) An Extra-ordinary General Meeting shall be convened by the Director following a written demand addressed

to the Director or either Co-Director and signed by a minimum of ten members.

ARTICLE 5 (d) Preliminary written notification of the Annual General Meeting shall be given not less than four weeks in advance, and the Committee shall prepare by the end of September each year, nominations for the next Committee, such nominations to be circularised to members not less than a fortnight prior to the Annual General Meeting. WARMINSTER - Is it worth going there?

Frequently I am asked the question, "Is anything still happening down at Warminster?" or, "Is it really a good place for UFO-spotting?" I can of course only give a personal assessment and it is this: I believe that two of the best areas for sky-watching, both from the point of view of accessibility and the number of incidents reported are that part of the West country between Stonehenge and Glastonbury, which includes Warminster, and Sussex, particularly the South Downs. This is not to say that other counties - Essex and Hertfordshire to name but two - are not attractive in this respect also, - I was born in Sussex and could be biased! So far as Warminster itself is concerned, whilst obviously, situated as it is close to army 'territory' there is additional scope for misidentification, - also plenty of scope for the misguided hoaxer - that said, Warminster is the only place I have twice seen UFOs myself; the same applies to several other people of my acquaintance. I would add too, that such sightings were often made completely independently of those of Arthur Shuttlewood and certainly bear him out in his claims that the area around Warminster may well be one of special Ufological interest. Clearly, with large numbers of people skywatching in the area more sightings are going to be reported. It is up to us all to avoid misreporting, to watch out for the hoaxer and above all to report all the details we can of what we consider to be genuine sightings and incidents.

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In UFOS OVER THE AMERICAS by Jim & Coral Lorenzen, an early and possibly the strangest contact case is described in which a man in Lima, Peru, going under the initials "C.A.V.", was confronted by ufo occupants after sighting their disc-shaped craft in 1949.

They are described as like "mummies" in appearance, without sex, an all-over towel-like skin, no ears, eyes, but a body with head, legs joined together ending in one large foot. They moved on this single foot like a dancer, (perhaps a swaying, shuffling movement). They possessed arms ending in hands which had four fingers stuck together with an opposing thumb. Their bodies were proportionate in human terms and about 5½ft. in height. Their faces were featureless but where the eyes would be they had a strip of jellyish substance with a single "bubble" in the centre which was movable and obviously served as an eye. The noses appeared as if when a human pulls a stocking over his face.

They asked "C.A.V." where they were, apparently being under the impression they had descended in North America. They appeared concerned with human atomic experiments and insisted on seeing C.A.V.'s "chief". Their method of reproduction was by simply dividing themselves in two, which one of the creatures obliging did for the witness. When this happened both "parts" were thus "born" automatically endowed with all the knowledge and experience of the single entity. They spoke in English and Spanish, though the witness was unable to be clear as to whether the creatures actually spoke by voice or telepathically, stating (understandably) that he did not feel himself during the experience.

He made an appointment to meet them again on the following day, intending to bring back the Press or someone of note, but, not being sure when the time came whether or not the strange event had actually happened, he returned alone but after waiting for some hours saw no sign of the aliens. Of special interest was his mention of a short trip in their ufo, which was devoid of interior furnishings or instrumentation of any kind. The being forecast that in the far future earthmen would become as they were, referring to us at present as "backward" when the witness brought up the question of God. (See illustration on page 16)
