This is the last issue of this magazine, at present, in its present form. Due to CNK being under new management for a while. Due to the 'take-over' contents may not be in the set order.

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

It is, a rare occasion when one editor honours another with the invitation to compose a contribution, and must be commended. I am very pleased to be able to write for Cosmology Newslink, and most sincerely hope that it will be far from the last occasion I do such a favour.

I should perhaps inaugurate this piece by stating my own views concerning UFOs..... I should, but I will refrain, as I vehemently believe that they are, for the most totally irrelevant and of no direct consequence. Moreover, I do not subscribe to the thankfully diminishing theory that editors (and contributors - should emphasise their personal views within the context of UFOs and related subjects (or perhaps within any context). It has long been the fault of man to believe what he wishes to believe, and damn what is really in front of his eyes. By this, I simply wish to indicate that I, one person in this human race, has no burning desire to thrust my own ideas onto the whole of the UFO-genre. We must study with an open mind, cross-bred with scientific minded curiosity and good old common sense. If we can do those small things we may well be on our way to exploring an interesting and deep-rooted subject with objectivity, and a general coolness

which will not permit any great percentage of mental deviation.

Although UFOs have been somewhat scientifically studied (in various degrees) for almost 30 years, and have been seen since earliest history and beyond, we are really no better off than last year, or the year before that. Why? I think that this is because we have not altered our method of approach for some time. This is not a candid opinion -- voiced by a solitary David T. Prockter; it has been mentioned by so many people, that I begin to lose count. Scientific study, has to follow certain rules and laws, yet UFOs seem that they either don't know the rules or quiet frequently bend the rules. We have created rules for UFOs, which are ridiculous, wheather you look at them either with a scientific approach of simply with the approach of a reasoning mind.

Rules?? That UFOs follow ley lines-- that every June 24th UFOs reappear in great numbers, that UFOs are all from outer space that they are magnetically pow-

erd....there are numerous "Rules" which are in a far better and befitting light when they are dispensed with completely and are viewed as museum pieces.

By disowning these "rules" I in no way am attempting to replace them with my own or those of any other person or group of persons. We must listen to each word that is spoken, but with a discerning ear which is hopefully in possession of a brain. But we must avoid any form of cultism at all cost. This cannot be emphasised

too greatly. The study must not take precedence withⁿ the sphere of your normal life. It is like taking work home from the office, and the result is misdirection of one sort or another. Many people within the realms of the study of the UFO have had to seek out mental treatment. This of course, does not present a very good view of the students of the subject to the 'outside world' which on reflection is maybe not worth bothering about to begin with.

To close, please walk with caution-you never know what you could step on.

PHILOSOPHICAL VIEWPOINTS

MAN DIVIDED

I have been asked by the editor to write a short article on a subject that has nothing to do with UFOs, Bermuda Triangles or whatever, but is concerned with a mystery which has eluded Man for centuries, and still does: his own mind, his emotions and the potential inherent in Man's nature.

According to the Bible, God made us in his own image. Does this mean that we may have God-like powers if we did but know it?

Most people have accepted the now outmoded Freudian concept of mind as a conscious unchanging entity which is influenced in mysterious ways by the vast unknown unconscious. This is only one theory, and should be considered as such -

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I don't have the space here to do justice to such a vast subject but can only hope to whet the reader's appetite for further enquiry.

The average man is a sleep-walking robot, acting and reacting, loving and hating, aggressively asserting himself with loudly expressed opinions.

Many who would consider themselves as sane, rational and reasonable human beings will react violently, like conditioned rats, to anything which contradicts their own view of reality.

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Man is diminishing and limiting himself and his universe

within walls of steel and glass; and the housewife pottering about the house waiting for her husband and children.

There is the museum keeper, and the orchestra conductor, each living within a fragment of life, each fragment becoming extraordinary important, unrelated, in contradiction to other fragments. The religious fragment is unrelated to the factory and the factory to the artist etc; the dogooder and the reformer are trying to patch up the broken pieces." And "It is the mind and heart that divide, God and hate, love and violence."

Perhaps, though, there is hope for man despite this. Perhaps, we are all slowly and painfully evolving towards a mentally more advanced type of being, as some theorists would have it.

In the "Occult" by Colin Wilson (Mayflower Books) he describes the vast potentialities of hitherto unsuspected mental powers explored by various seekers after truth, such as Aldous Huxley, Gurdjieff, Ouspensky, Crowley, Jung, etc.

In a section on Ouspensky, a disciple of Gurdjieff, the Russian mystic and psychologist, Ouspensky describes a vision that he had quite spontaneously while walking in Petrograd: "Suddenly I saw that the man who was walking towards me was asleep..... although his eyes were open, he was walking along obviously immersed in dreams, which ran like clouds across his face. It entered my mind that, if I could look at him long enough, I should see his dreams." In this, it's as if Ouspensky momentarily "woke up" from his sleepwalking state and entered a realm of the mind which, unknowingly, we may be denying ourselves a state which exists parallel to, yet includes, our "normal consciousness" and of which we all have momentary glimpses. Perhaps this state is man's natural inheritance but has been narrowed and clouded over by day to day concerns, the restricting influence of modern life and the poverty of man's own idea of himself. I can only touch on this immense and complex area here but I hope I have interested the reader enough to encourage him to delve further into these matters. I leave you with this quotation from Shelley on the death of his friend: "Peace, peace, he is not dead, he does not sleep. He has awakened from the dream of life-'tis we who, lost in stormy visions, phantoms keep in unprofitable strife." Hugh McAtcer

YOU and ME

YOUR EDITOR INVITED ME TO CONTRIBUTE AN OCCASIONAL COLUMN TO "COSMOLOGY NEWSLINK." YOU WILL FIND THE FOLLOW-UP ARTICLE- THAT I REFERED 'TO, AT THE END OF MY FIRST ONE (CNK No.7),

The Daily Telegraph colour Magazine for 3rd March 1972 carried an article by Kenneth Gatland on the search for life in the Universe entitled-- 'Is There anyone Up There Like Us ? 'In this feature he referred to Prof Asor Zdzienicki Kopal of the University of Manchester.

On the front cover of the magazine is quoted a statement from the professor, not contained in Gatland's interesting article. It reads as follows:

"A thousand, or ten thousand, years of evolutionary difference is just nothing on cosmic scales; and the chances that we could come across another civilisation in the Universe at approximately the same level of development - and with which we could effect some kind of intellectual understanding - are, therefore, vanishingly small. And such being the case, what gain- I repeat - could we derive from contacts with hypothetical civilisations which are likely to be removed, not thou-

sands, but millions, or hundreds of millions, of years from our level ?

Certainly the risks entailed in such an encounter would vastly exceed any possible interest - let alone benefit; and could easily prove fatal. Therefore, should we ever hear that 'space-phone', ringing in the form of observational evidence which may admit of no other explanation, for God's sake let us not answer; but rather make ourselves as inconspicuous as we can to avoid attracting attention....."

Gatland, in his article, quotes another scientist, Dr. Krafft A. Ehrlicke, Space Division, North American Rockwell Corporation, who puts the possibility of contact differently:

"I believe encounter with an alien civilisation will be an elevating or dangerous experience, stimulating and interesting in any case, but not degrading on the grounds that it refutes the cherished, but not very plausible, postulate that we are of a unique quality. There are, of course, those who say we as mere mortals have no business questioning the secrets of the Universe. I cannot

imagine a more foreboding, apocalyptic vision than the fate of a mankind possessed with cosmic powers and condemned to solitary confinement on one small planet."

That is certainly a more courageous and enlightened viewpoint. However, the purpose of this article is to reply to Dr. Kopal. The gist of his argument is that it would be wise not to answer any signals (though he did not state that, this must be implied also) or follow up evidential observations of a galactic civilisation as they would be so advanced compared with us. In short, he is saying that, our mankind would be like primitive savages to them.

We, of course, must look like savages to any advanced race out there. You have only to look in your daily newspapers for full confirmation of this; war, violence, crime and moral decadence are our regular breakfast-time reading. Nevertheless despite our obvious drawbacks, I would contend that the Sky People are friendly towards us and this derives from a parental association going back aeons ago. Although I would agree with some UFO researchers that there have been some hostile reports—these come from an

area around our planet—the Sky People, in my personal view, are predominantly friendly and understand our situation.

Now, I will present some evidence to show that not only did they put us here originally but have been giving us "shots in the arm" over a very long period and that they have been keeping a careful eye on us, educating us up as it were, within the limits of Cosmic Law, to the time when we will be able to take our place in a galactic civilisation.

I have noticed that some UFO writers have complained about this situation and said that the Sky People are making an unholy mess of things and, if they are all that friendly, why do they not come down now and give us all their secrets? In short, sort out the terrible messes we have made for ourselves. I have just mentioned Cosmic Law. In my view you may not agree—they cannot do that. They are very advanced and we are not. We have got to make the grade ourselves. Within certain limits they can give us certain 'assists' when we are ready for them. However, I think that if a really critical state was to arrive on this planet, for instance a nuclear

war, they might possibly intervene, but, of course, I don't really know; they might not do so. After all we have had catastrophes in the past. They have all the time in the universe. It is more likely that they may have overcome death and be immortals; remember, Dr. Kopal spoke of them possibly being millions of years ahead of us. On this planet our medical men are working on the possibility of extending life far beyond the usual seventy years or so. Thus if they are immortal and this planet goes through another catastrophe then why should this affect their experiment here. No doubt it will all come right in the end.

Incidentally, our famed British astronomer, Fred Hoyle, wrote in his book 'Of Men and Galaxies' - as follows:-¹
"You are all familiar with an ordinary telephone directory. You want to speak to someone, you look up his number and you dial the appropriate code. My speculation is that a similar situation exists and has existed for billions of years, in the Galaxy. My

speculation is that an inter-
change of messages is going on, on a vast scale, all the time and that we are as unaware of it as a pygmy in the African forests is unaware of the radio messages that flash, at the speed of light, around the earth. My guess is that there might be a million or more subscribers to the Galactic directory, Our problem is to get our name into that directory."

Well, there you have Britain's most famous astronomer striking out on a different line to Dr. Kopal.

It is my contention that we are seeded out here from outer space; man is universal. Darwin's theory of evolution is widely accepted as regards life in general, but in the case of mankind it has one drawback. The emergence of the brain of mankind on this planet was too quick. Even Darwin was worried on this score and realised that natural selection might not be the correct answer in respect of mankind. It has long been accepted that there is a hypothetical 'missing link'.

A contemporary American writer, Otto O. Binder quotes Max H. Flindt, as follows:-²
"...Namely that mankind appeared so suddenly on the scene be-

cause he was a planned hybrid, a cross between super-intelligent star-men and sub-intelligent two-legged creatures on earth."

Binder goes on to quote Flindt further to prove that man could not have evolved himself in the brief time allotted for him in the traditional evolutionary scale. Flindt wrote:

"Except for man, the best that nature could do on land was to develop three great ape families. This meant that it took nature 500,000,000 years to develop one billion neurons (the maximum capacity of an anthropoid brain). At this rate one neuron was developed every six months. ... man, with his ten billion neurons, should have taken ten times as long as the apes in order to develop his fantastic brain. Ten times 500 millions is 5 billion years."

Bender comments: "Yet man and his superb thinking organ they would have us believe, came out of the evolutionary pot in a mere two million years. Obviously, nature did not create man's brain. The Sky-men did, in an ancient breeding experiment, or a series of them."

I wholeheartedly agree with

Otto Binder. In fact, in my first book - 'The Sky People' (3)-published in 1960, I advanced the same sort of idea that a race of people from a far-off planet had bred with us. This idea was further advanced in my third tome, 'Forgotten Heritage.' There are, of course, the famous verses in Genesis about the Sons of God coming down and mingling with the daughters of men. Other countries throughout the world have similar stories in their scriptures, legends and folk-lore, telling of god-like beings coming down from the skies and fraternising with us mortals.

I have referred to 'shots in the arm', given by the Sky People. Let me amplify this a bit. There are incidents in early history - one in particular about the legendary St. Germain 'the man who never died.' - which I have referred to in my latest book, 'The Eternal Subject' 4

In more modern times, as most ufologists know, there was a big 'flap' of UFO sightings in 1897, over U.S.A; these took the form of 'dirigibles'. Now, this is very

interesting; it was not until three years later that Count Von Zeppelin flew his craft at a speed of only 18 m.p.h., but the UFO 'dirigibles' seen over the U.S.A., in 1897 flew at 1,000 m.p.h.! It seems to me that the Sky People were showing us something we could do.

In 1909, a large number of UFOs—mostly cigar shaped—were over Britain and later over New Zealand; earlier in the year over U.K. and later over N.Z. according to records. Many of these were flying at speeds beyond our capabilities at that time. Here, once again I suggest that the ufo-nauts were showing us the way.

In 1932 a number of 'winged aircraft' were seen over Scandinavia, often flying in blizzards, seemingly quite impervious to the effects of the storms. They have been described by the well known American writer, John A. Keel 5.

In 1946 we had the 'ghost rockets' which appeared over Finland and Sweden. They were, surely, telling us then—'improve on this and you can achieve spaceflight!'

So it seems to me that there has been some kind of progress

and that the Sky People have all along been trying to lead us to the stars, to join them.

I would postulate that they are capable of using ESP powers, telepathy, travelling in the invisible universe, as described in my last article (issue 7 CWK), but manifest from areas in our own physical universe. I appreciate that this is a hell of a lot to swallow, but, at any rate, it may give you some food for thought.

Dr. Kopal has not taken into account the possibility that we may have been 'planted' here in the first instance. Neither do I see why we should fear people thousands of years in advance of ourselves, especially if they put us here. If these people were only two hundred years in advance of us (which is most unlikely) I would agree with Dr. Kopal. We know from our history that on this planet more advanced civilisations have conquered and wiped out lesser ones. However, I am naive enough to think that a galactic civilisation, thousands or even millions of years, as Dr. Kopal suggests—in advance of us would have got to the stage where fighting, wars and skull-

diggery, would long ago have been eliminated.

* Editor's Comments and Summary on Mr. Trench's article:

Since Brinsley Le Poer Trench wrote that article a lot of water has gone under the bridge but a lot of it rings clear. I wish to add my notes on the subject of WHERE WE COME FROM by adding the following:-

1. Where does mankind FIT IN WITH NATURE? I don't think

we do. Man seems to NEED machinery. Man loves machines. Which animal on earth invents and uses such things? -NONE! Certain birds and animals are only now finding out how to use simple TOOLS. When an animal discovers that tools help make life easier for it it uses them. There are to my knowledge three such animals who use 'tools; one is a monkey which uses a stick to poke down ant nests in order to get the ants out to eat them. (I hope I am correct) But this is still primitive by human standards. Related sightings to note:

18th June 1972 ENGLAND...

'Lowestoft' lifeboat was launched on this date after red, green, and bluish lights, believed to have been caused by a meteorite breaking up, were mistaken for a distress signal.

17th August 1971, England:

West Bromwich. Elderly man saw a dark grey object which was slightly oval. He was driving along at the time and opened the window to make sure it was not a reflection on car window. It remained there for a few moments so the witness stopped the car and pointed out the object to a few passers by and then it suddenly disappeared like a light being switched off.

17th August 1971. ENGLAND:

Object, shape of rugby ball with 3 "streamers" coming out of the back of it, was seen by a man.

Arthur Godfrey, famous TV and radio star revealed an encounter with a UFO during a flight in his private plane. The Co-pilot on the flight was Frank Munciello. Although the sighting occurred sometime ago this was the first time it was discussed, publicly. The encounter took place during a night flight from New York to Washington. The plane was near Philadelphia when a brilliantly lighted object suddenly appeared off the right wing. Godfrey hurriedly banked to the left, to avoid a possible collision. Then he radioed the FAA tower at Philadelphia.

"Any traffic scheduled near us?" he asked. "None," the tower told him.

"Well, there's darned well something up here," Godfrey responded. As he and Munciello watched the strange object, it reversed course, quickly circled behind them and came up on the left wing. He turned sharply, trying to pull away. But the UFO instantly banked with him. He tried again to shake it off, but the unknown craft matched every move.

"It stayed there on the left wing no matter what I did," Godfrey said.

He admitted that he and Munciello were scared by the UFO's close manoeuvres until it veered away and disappeared.

WAS HARLOW'S U.F.O ALSO OHIO'S?

Our man in Harlow, Essex, England., Mr. Edward O' Hare has been good enough to send in a photostat copy of a tremendous UFO flap that took place in this New town on June 30 1967. The amazing coincidence here is that the photo taken in Harlow on

Mr. John Lander, aged 20, who works at Cossor's Harlow, and a keen naturalist, recently saw a "strange thing" in the sky at night. He joined local UFO groups, and formed a small group of spotters himself.

On Saturday evening, with two friends, he started watching the sky over Epping from a farm just south of Harlow. The three men were equipped with telescopes, detectors, and cine and still cameras.

"It was a bit cloudy, but we saw a few things like satellites in the first three hours," said Mr. Lander, "then at about 2.10 a.m. we saw a bright red cigar-shaped light over Epping going in the direction of North Weald. There was no noise, and it was about threequarters the diameter of the full moon.

"As it got nearer the ground the light intensified, becoming nearly white, and then it seemed to stop, and hover, swaying like a falling leaf."

He added: "We were really scared, thinking it was going to land. Thank goodness we had the camefas."

The object was in sight for five or six minutes, claimed the observers, and then it shot off "at tremendous speed" towards London.

The three men, John Lander,

Peter Philpott, and Bob Brown, all of whom live in Harlow, hope the cine films they took will help to back their claims. One of Britain's foremost authorities on UFO phenomena, Mr. Ben Caswell, of Potter Street, Harlow, said this week: "This is tremendous news. There has been so much activity in the Epping area during the past year, and now we have some solid evidence to work on."

BALL OF LIGHT

There was more UFO news on Monday when an Epping family watched a "very bright ball of white light" hovering over their house in Clover Lane.

They were Mr. and Mrs. Terrence Cooper, who were called out by their 16-year-old daughter Lesley, and David Hall, her boy friend, at about 11 p.m. to look at the object. Gillian, their other daughter, also got up to look. "It was too high up to distinguish any shape. It hovered over our house, and then began moving slowly off in a semi-circle." Mrs. Joyce Cooper told the Gazette. "Then it stopped for a moment, before shooting off at terrific speed, and then the light went out...perhaps it went behind a cloud," she added.

Several reports of cigar-shaped objects claimed she heard


a high-pitched noise..objects over Epping Forest were..made at the weekend. The three Harlow spotters claimed their UFO was cigar-shaped, but the sensitivity of the film has picked out four separate objects.

Was this the case also with the Ohio sighting, which runs as follows:

NOTES. The Dunmow, sighting by Michael Perry was passed onto the Essex UFO study group for evaluation. The Epping report should have been titled such-apologies. Epping seems a good place for future investigation, if deemed so by the investigating body.


The spate of flying saucer sightings that hit the United

But National Bulletin has uncovered new evidence that indicates the continuing activity of our alien visitors. The American sightings have decreased, only because the saucers have discovered the grandeur of the great North country. Like the refugees from America's collapsing urban centres and draft dodgers before them, the saucer men have skipped across the border to settle in Canada!

Henry McKay, of Agincourt, Ontario, is Canada's leading saucer expert, and it is his painstaking work that has revealed the massive influx of UFOs into Canada during the last year. Take the example of farmer Leo Paul Chaput of Ontario. At 2 one morning last summer, Leo spotted a bright object coming down into a field not far from his home. Next morning he went out to the field to find 40ft of burned grass; doughnut-holed."




THIS MYSTERIOUS object was photographed over Long Beach, California.

THE INVADERS are here and now, walking about the streets of Dagenham and Barking. So says our very own star man Roy Lake — or 'UFO' as he is known to his friends.

Father-of-three Roy first became interested in 'Unidentified Flying Objects' when he first spotted one near his home in Parsloes Park, Dagenham, seven years ago.

Now he firmly believes our visitors from outer space have been living among us for years.

"Mostly they work for the government or hold other official positions whereby they can gain information useful to their superiors," said 35-year-old Roy of Parsloes Avenue. "You could even walk past one in the street in Dagenham and you wouldn't realise, because I believe they look just like us."

One of his most recent UFO sightings was just four weeks ago, at the Heathway end of his road.

He said: "I looked up in the dark sky and I saw what I thought at first was an extra bright star. Then it started moving so I thought it must have been a satellite.

"I got on the tube at the Heathway and went to Chalk Farm to see my mother. When I got out the other end it was still there. And when I returned to Dagenham I looked up and there it was again, but then it disappeared dramatically."

And last October Roy saw a cigar-shaped object hovering over Parsloes Park. It was pointed out to him by a neighbour. It was visible for about three minutes then just vanished he said.

Recently in Wales there was an earth tremor which was said to be a meteor but Roy has his doubts.

RIDICULE

"For a start a meteor would burn up before hitting the earth, and secondly a yellow light was seen. But as usual everything has been hushed up," added Roy.

Many local people have reported their findings to Roy including a 15-year-old lad who also spotted a cigar-shaped object hovering over Parsloes Park.

"I think there are many more people who have seen UFOs in the borough but are too frightened to say anything for fear of being ridiculed," added Roy.

Now Roy, the Essex representative of the British Interplanetary Space Travel Research Association, is hoping other enthusiasts will contact him with a view to forming a more local club. He can be reached at 593 2011.



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

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

UNIDENTIFIED flying objects have been the subject of endless debate, speculation and high-powered research. Sceptics may dismiss UFOs as "pie in the sky."

But however much they may scoff, the believers argue their case with facts, figures and information gathered over the centuries.

Barking UFO Study Group was set up recently to further this fact gathering.

Many members say they have seen UFOs. And a belief that the public should know all the facts about "ufology" inspires discussion and research into all local reported sightings.

Mr. Ron Markwick, consultant to the group, is a 43-year-old Canadian. He has studied and worked in many scientific fields including radio, radar and electronics.

He says: "I first became interested in the phenomena in my teens. No one believed me when I related how I witnessed a glowing, white mass floating down from a clear, sunny sky."

"But today, case histories of such phenomenal are listed — they are called fireballs.

"There are other types of unidentified flying objects. Some vary in size, being saucer or cigar-shaped. They vary also in their characteristics.

"Some pulsate, or gyrate, and their speeds occasionally exceed anything man has made.

"The Egyptians named their flying saucers sun ships and sun discs.

"Our primitive ancestors left much information in pictorial form on the walls of caves.

"Today we have tracking stations, radio and radar, yet we still face this UFO puzzle.

"People who have seen UFOs include scientists, airline pilots, navigators, members of the church, police officers and military personnel who are trained to be good observers.

"People from all walks of life are involved in UFO phenomena. So often people are hesitant to give facts for fear of being ridiculed or of losing a job in a high position.

"Considering the Americans alone have spent nearly one quarter of a million pounds on the UFO project it tends to indicate there must be something in it."

"Astronauts are familiar with sighting UFOs since they have photographed them on space junks.

"How can a fragment of the imagination give a trace on a radar screen? Why have military planes of various nations, including Britain, pursued UFOs, so often with disastrous result?"

"How in this modern era have we lost numerous ships and planes — even a formation of planes — without a piece of tell-tale debris?"

"Investigators are baffled even after extensive searches. Many have concluded that the disappearances must have occurred instantly."

The group's founder Mr. Roy Lake, of Parloes Avenue, Dagenham, pledges to treat each claim seriously

Aviator Assails Condon Report

One of the nation's pioneers in aviation recently called the Condon Report "one of the most deliberate cover-ups ever perpetrated on the public."

John Northrop, 80-year-old founder of Northrop Aircraft Co. and co-founder of the Lockheed Corp., told an audience at Caltech that "The 21st century will die laughing at the Condon Report."

Northrop, a believer in UFOs, told the audience he had never seen one himself, but based his belief on a "hard core sighting" reported to him by Max Stanley, Northrop's chief pilot and a close friend in the early days of the aviation firm.

Stanley, according to Northrop, was on a 1950 flight from Texas to California and was flying at 20,000 feet when he and two companions spotted a metallic translucent object high above them — about 80,000 feet — which appeared at times to fly sideways.

"I have never seen a UFO myself, but Max Stanley's report is good enough for me," commented Northrop.



UFOs FROM BEHIND THE IRON CURTAIN

Their conclusion is that reports of UFO sightings in the East reveal a pattern of similarity and repetition exactly parallel to experiences in the West, that 'conventional' scientists have been much too quick to dismiss. They have no theory to explain the mystery - they believe that this is not their task. But they believe that there is a mystery to be solved, and that the task for present research is to record all the detail possible, in the hope

of finding not an answer, but clues to the discovery of a method of studying the phenomenon.

Are UFOs extraterrestrial in origin? Are they connected with attempts to communicate from civilisations far beyond ours, in other galaxies? Are they connected with other psychic phenomena, such as thought-transference? There are Russian scientists, for instance, who think so.

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THE PENTAGON FEARS U.F.O INVASION THIS YEAR !

AUGUST - NATIONAL POLICE GAZETTE 1974

The Pentagon, which has for the last 25 years tried to pooh-pooh the existence of UFOs, has now awakened to the grim reality that the world may face an invasion by alien beings.

Today, a special unit has been set up by the joint Chiefs of Staff to map defenses of Earth should an interplanetary war erupt. The specter of creatures from another planet descending on Earth is giving space scientists nightmares.

The Pentagon has no doubt that life exists in outer space. The Pentagon has overwhelming scientific evidence that other intelligent civilisations exist on other planets.

A few years ago radio astronomers at the Mullard Radio Astronomy Observatory in Cambridge, England, began to talk of "Little Green Men," when they discovered a mysterious radio source in the constellation

of Vulpecula. Scientists assumed it was a message for space. But this theory was treated as an "imaginary assumption," until a recent conference on extraterrestrial intelligence (ETI) held in America. The technical details surrounding the Soviet radio surveillance were given to the Pentagon. The Russian report complemented a study made by NASA on interstellar communication called Project Cyclops. The Agency is now rushing plans to build a giant radio "ear" four million times as sensitive as any now in use.

There are no doubts among Pentagon experts that extraterrestrial life exists. A few years ago the Chinese-born astrophysicist Huang Su-shu, of North-western University, outlined the regions around stars where life could exist. These stellar regions were neither too hot, so that water would evaporate, nor too cold, so that it would freeze.

Where, in outer space, does the Pentagon think life exists? On the stars Tau Ceti and Epsilon Eridani.

On the cosmic scale, Tau Ceti and Epsilon Eridani are both rel-

actively close---about 11 light years away. (A light year is the distance light travels in one year approximately six million million miles).

It is the conclusion of the experts that the barrage of UFOs that have been circulating the earth for years are observation satellites sent to earth from the civilisation on Tau Ceti. This, UFOs are the object of diligent observation by the Pentagon. Despite the governments' silence to the general public, a sense of urgency has penetrated all orders to official observers.

The "Merint Radiotelegraph Procedure", for early warning in defense of the North American continent, requests immediate reports of "unidentified flying objects." This rates top priority.

This might be a crucial year that will see a massive UFO invasion of Earth. Dr. Nikolai Burganosky, an eminent cosmic authority of the Kremlin, reports that the increased frequency of radio signals monitored from another planet indicates contact with UFOs en route to Earth. On the basis of calculations, the number of UFOs number into the thousands. There is also the growing fear among some scientists, that the rockets

both Russia and the United States have been sending to the Moon, Mars and elsewhere in space, have alarmed the civilisations of other planets into panic. They might be determined to invade Earth, before Earthmen invade their celestial territories. Thus, not only the Pentagon, but the Kremlin, as well as the military establishments of all major powers, have to blueprint defenses against an interplanetary invasion.

For many years, the Pentagon has been involved in the controversy over UFOs. When they first attracted international attention in the 1940s, the U.S. Air Force tried to minimize their importance. At that time, it was government policy not to panic the public. It is still the policy of the Pentagon, since public alarm would only complicate their responsibility. The fact is that data about UFOs was withheld.

It wasn't until the National Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomena was set up, that the truth about the UFOs became available to the public.

This organisation staunchly maintains that our government, through the U.S. Air Force--- which performs the official

investigations of unidentified flying objects (UFOs)—"has practiced an intolerable degree of secrecy, keeping the public in the dark about the amount and possible significance of UFO evidence."

Adm. R. H. Killenoetter, who commanded the CIA from 1946 to 1950 and was one of the founders of NICAP, has stated:

"Behind the scenes, high-ranking Air Force Officers are soberly concerned about the UFOs, but through official secrecy and ridicule, many citizens are led to believe the unknown flying objects are nonsense... To hide the fact, the Air Force has silenced its personnel..."

The particular Air Force department that was originally in charge of investigating UFOs was called Project Blue Book. It was a division of the Air Technical Intelligence Centre at Dayton, Ohio—and it took its job seriously.

The original head of Project Blue Book was Capt. Edward J. Ruppelt, who ran the group for two and a half years, until September 1953. Highly Skeptical in the beginning, Ruppelt eventually concluded that most of the reports constituted valid sightings, and the most plausible explanation was that UFOs

were extraterrestrial. He expressed this view in numerous classified reports but was prohibited from stating it publicly. Upon his retirement, however, he published a book entitled: "The Report On Unidentified Flying Objects", in which he carefully and painstakingly reviewed hundreds of sightings. NICAP also quoted a published statement by H. Percy Wilkins, British Astronomer, who claims to have observed three UFOs each of which was 50 ft in diameter. Another outspoken scientist is Hermann Oberth who says they come from Tau Ceti and epsilon Eridani, and are doing research here."

HAS BETTY FOUND ? EVIDENCE OF UFOs



Is this proof that an Unidentified Flying Object crashed into trees? Betty Jones our correspondent proudly displays what she feels is evidence of a UFO encounter with the trees.

This report of a grooved tree comes from Betty Jones who writes the following:

"Lee A Finley and his son Don came upon a thicket of twisted off trees in October or December of 1956 near Granet, Oregon. An unidentified force ripped through a thicket of trees, which left a path of 12 to 15 feet wide of 50 to 100 trees, 3 to 4" thick, that had their tops twisted, some counterclockwise, off. Some were scraped smooth, pulled out of the ground, roots and all. Many bigger trees had been grooved out smooth by some unknown force or object. I investigated this site in June 26, 1973 and found one large tree that had been grooved 12½ to 14" horizontal groove, 2 or more inches wide, and 2" deep, which was as smooth as if it had been sanded. It contained no metal or paint marks, and there was not any pitch in the groove. I had a tree that was pulled out by the roots and gashed, and the top tore off, also a section that was tore out of another tree, it is sliced in half. I also have a piece that is small, that was sliced from a pulled out tree over 30 feet tall. I have some photos of the area but the one of the big groove is too dark, the tree is still standing in the Oregon forest so I may be able to get it someday." Mrs. Jones wrote that on Sept 18th 1973. A footnote Betty writes: "The ground was not disturbed except for the pulled out trees. The strange grooves slashed into some of the trees varied in height from just over two feet to more than six feet. Whatever moved a tree 30 feet tall from the edge of the woods into a meadow must have had tremendous strength to uproot it and move it that distance. Was the object out of control but came out unharmed? If so, it must have been almost indestructible."

The creature started running, Greenhaw said.


"I jumped into my car and took off after him," Greenhaw said. "but I couldn't even catch up with him in my patrol car. He was running faster than any human I ever saw."

On March 26th, 1974, the Betz family of Fort George Island, which lies off the Florida Coast near Jacksonville, was walking over their property to inspect possible damage caused by a recent brush fire, when their 21-year-old son Terry discovered a metallic ball slightly less than eight inches in diameter. Regarding it merely as a curiosity, he took it home and placed it on the window seat in his room where it lay for a couple of weeks. Then one day he noted that playing certain notes on his guitar caused it to "vibrate like a tuning fork." Other reported phenomena: 1) It moved at times under its own volition, 2) seemed to vibrate at low frequency "like a motor was running inside" and 3) when placed near it, a pet

poodle cringed and tried to cover its ears. Checked by a metallurgist at Jacksonville Naval Air Station, its outer surface was found to be of stainless steel (magnetic ferrous alloy #431). He estimated the shell to be about $\frac{1}{2}$ inch thick. After notices appeared in the press Dr. Hynok of Northwestern University requested that the ball be sent to him for examination. APRO investigators informed Mrs. Betz of the National Enquirer \$50,000 award and suggested that the sphere be taken to New Orleans to a meeting of the National Enquirer UFO Panel where decisions could be made as to the scientific procedures to be followed in further testing. Subsequently, son Terry carried the ball personally to New Orleans. Dr. James A. Harder, APRO'S consultant in civil engineering, comments that an x-ray of a sphere should result in a doughnut-shaped presentation. However, the Navy X-Ray still shows two internal spheres after 300 KV Xray bombardment has rendered the shell invisible. This indicates that the internal material is more dense than the stainless steel shell. Thus, a substantial portion of the weight is in the internal

material and the shell could be much thinner than $\frac{1}{2}$ inch. Also the sphere exhibits four magnetic poles—two positive and two negative. The magnetic configuration is not concentric.

It has been suggested that the object is a "time and tide" marker but its specific gravity (about 2.2) eliminates that possibility. If the audio transponding capability is verified it may be a sea bottom marker. Such a device would be an asset to missile-launching submarines, giving them stable reference points for ballistics computations.

The Navy's failure to identify it could be due to "need to know" restrictions related to classified devices. Its discovery at least five miles from the nearest water—is a serious obstacle to the latter explanation however. The Navy has asked for an opportunity to submit it to an acid bath for an attempt to locate a welding seam. Our phone conversations with Mrs. Betz indicate a serious, objective interest on her part to find out what that object is. She does not try to sensationalise and accepts the fact that "it may turn out to be nothing." (From APRO USA)

* If any readers of CNK know what this ball is, or if anyone has "lost" this item, I'm sure APRO would be more than pleased to hear from you. If no such luck, then the hypothesis that it could be extraterrestrial must not be ruled out. I suggest APRO to connect the ball up with an ultra-sonic resonator and see if it begins to become weightless. —Editor.

FROM MIDNIGHT August 5, 1974 U.S.A. :-

The United States government isn't revealing all it knows about UFO sightings. That's the basic claim of a new book by author Ralph Blum and his wife, Judy, who wrote "BEYOND EARTH: MAN'S CONTACT WITH UFOs" But according to MIDNIGHT they ran into a snag when they tried to check into government files on UFOs. The book centres on the visit of "silvery robot-like creatures" to Pascagoula, Mississippi, in October 1973. Two shipyard workers had been taken aboard an extraterrestrial spacecraft suspended in mid-air, and examined with a "large, laser beam eye." Following the incident, U.S Air Force doctors gave the workers a lie detector test, and examinations. The author was allowed to witness some tests which led to him saying: "There's no way, in my opinion, that the Pascagoula incident was a hoax, as some reports undoubtedly are."

This story is a long one and space does not permit to tell all but briefly as follows:

Saturday afternoon on the Gulf Coast, looked like a normal afternoon, lots of activity outside sheriff's office with reporters etc. APRO was there. The two men were to be "grilled" by scientists. CNK takes up story from the ENQUIRER:

"Happen again? To him do you mean? (their spelling)


"Charlie, he said inside the spaceship he was laid down on nothing - he was weightless. He floated!"



FLYING OBJECT AT ORANGE FAIRGROUND 'IDENTIFIED'

By HERB SHANNON

The unidentified flying object in a University of California centennial exhibit in Costa Mesa will really fly — if the pilot can get its eight lawnmower engines all working at the same time.

The centerpiece of the 80-exhibit UC show set up in the Agriculture and Commerce building at Orange County Fairgrounds is a genuine flying saucer, complete with bubble-canopy cockpit.

Invented and built by Prof. Paul Moller, 29, a physics instructor at the UC Davis campus, the fiberglass craft is designed along the classic lines described by veteran UFO observers. It measures eight feet in diameter and features eight small propellers set in a wingless body circling the cockpit.

Each of the propellers is powered by a one-cylinder engine of the type used in heavy-duty power mowers, go-karts and the like. Their combined lift theoretically will allow the 225-pound saucer and its pilot to hover at altitudes up to 5,000 feet, or tilt to dart in any direction at 70 miles an hour.

The saucer on display at the fairgrounds has yet to fly, although Prof. Moller has demonstrated the feasibility of his idea by skimming

around Davis Airport at altitudes of a foot or so in two previous models.

All three of the wingless craft were built in the professor's home workshop in his garage. The prototype, like the latest model, is a single-seat job. The second one accommodates a passenger as well as the pilot and has four 35-horsepower motorcycle engines.

Moller plans to flight test the newest saucer in December, according to Terry Cole, director of the UC exhibition and also of the Student and Young Alumni Association at the Berkeley campus.

But the inventor has a serious problem to solve before he can test the flying saucer fully, even if he manages to crank up the last of the eight engines before the first one runs out of gas.

"He doesn't have a pilot's license," explained Cole.

Other exhibits in the UC Centennial Caravan which has been touring the state include a model of a propellerless electromagnetic submarine designed by two students at the Santa Barbara campus, a traffic safety display and 77 historical panels.

The road show celebrating 100 years of the university's accomplishments is open daily without admission charge from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. It closes at 5 p.m. Sunday, the final day.

PROPULSION

How DO UFOs fly, defying all known laws of science? Believe it or not it really must be something quite simple? REALLY? Right under our noses. Just can't put the finger on it! 
"The most interesting theory and a possible source of power is the "Vacuum Method." The U.F.I. creates a vacuum in the direction that is chosen by the occupants and virtually "Slides" towards the selected goal. A vacuum would eliminate noise and friction, hence they are seen to travel without noise or leaving a vapour trail. Inside a vacuum there would be no air currents to restrict the speed and put stress upon the craft. To achieve this vacuum the occupants would have to ionise the air in some manner, this would account for the changing colours, according to the amount of energy involved. It is interesting to note that UFOs only make noise when they are hovering and that is generally described as a 'hum' which varies in pitch.

As a means of power, I think it is more likely than nuclear energy which is primitive for such advanced crafts as UFOs most certainly are.

The ENIGMA of the
MISSING

Compiled and conducted by The Editor CNK is going to attempt a complete run down on all the disappearances, but it's a formidable task, and news sources are numerous. However here's the top of the situation:-

There are thousands of cases of unusual disappearances on record, some with human explanations. But what about these cases:

Back in the 1880s, David Lang, a farmer, disappeared without trace. One sunny day he was out plowing a field when, IN THE SIGHT OF FIVE WITNESSES, he walked over a small knoll, and he was never seen again—but he was HEARD again! Two days later it was found that the grass growing on the spot where Lang vanished turned a peculiar shade of brown. And for two years afterwards, people walking near the knoll could hear a faint voice crying. "Help me! Help me! THIS IS A TRUE AUTHENTICATED STORY.

Then there is the case of young Oliver Thomas an 11-year old farmers son, in Rhayader Wales, England, who on the night before Christmas of 1909 walked out of the house to fetch water from their well at 11.00pm, which he had done many times before. Only ten seconds passed on leaving the house when those in the kitchen were startled by his screams of terror. The family and guests ran into the yard, and with the light from a lantern were startled to see Oliver's footprints in the snow, trailing across the yard towards the well. The footprints extended about 75 ft., then abruptly ended. What they heard, though, that really frightened them was his shrieking voice yelling, "Help! They've got me! Help! Help! W There was an inquest, with witnesses testifying but it proved fruitless, because nobody knows to this day what happened to the Thomas boy.

Next to disappear were flight Lieutenant Day and pilot officer Stewart, who took off on a routine flight which was to have lasted about four hours. They, too, never returned. The next day July 25, 1924 in Iraq (then Mesopotamia), after intensive searching, their plane was found. There was fuel and

oil in the craft, and it started readily--but there was no sign of engine or mechanical failure. Searchers discovered two sets of boot prints made by Day and Stewart where they had jumped down from the aircraft. The prints went side by side for about forty yards, then abruptly vanished. A thorough search of the area was made for days, but nothing was ever found to establish the whereabouts of the two missing men. If as rumoured they were captured by a UFO, I can only assume that as the men were on a reconnaissance flight, they deliberately landed to take a closer look at 'something' which was to prove disastrous for them. If the hypothesis IS true, and UFOs ARE taking people, then CNK asks WHAT FOR? Probable answers:(ours only) Humans taken into alien space craft for FOOD. Earth humans treated as mere cabbages to them, to take as needed. Other reasons: An interstellar breeding experiment as already seen. Or a nicer thought, that the planet they were taken to, and the life there so far superior to us that the men decided to stay, or it was a one way trip anyway due to the distance involved. There was supposed to be a case of a UFO landing in the Essex area years ago and the contactee told me they come here every five years as it takes them five years (ours) to get back. Not all disappearances concern only single persons. There is an area known as the Bermuda Triangle, so called because disappearances have taken place in a triangular pattern, which is; Lies between Florida and Bermuda, across to Puerto Rico and back again to Florida through the Bahamas. This area, which certainly is not isolated, has claimed at least a thousand lives on numerous ships and aircraft in the past twenty years. One case goes thus: On Dec. 5, 1945, five TBM bombers lined up on runways at the Naval Air Station at Fort Lauderdale, Florida. It was a perfect day for flying, a routine patrol--weather was sunny and clear. The plan for the formation was to fly 160 miles due east, 40 miles to the north, then southwest, back to the air station. The flight was to last about two hours. At 2:02 pm the first plane left the runway and the other four followed in quick succession, heading east over the Atlantic at 215 mph. At 3:45pm the first word from the patrol was radioed to the base control room--and strange words it was, "Calling tower, this is an emergency...We seem to be off course. We cannot see land..repeat..we cannot see land." The tower radioed back to the worried patrol leader. "What is your position?" Came the reply: "We're not sure of our position, we can't be sure

just where we are. We seem to be lost." Lost? A flight of five planes manned by experienced crews on a perfect flying day as this? The tower radioed back. "Assume bearing due west."

Alarm was beginning to show in the patrol leader's voice when he replied: "We don't know which way is west...Everything is wrong...strange. We can't be sure of any direction. Even the ocean doesn't look as it should." The conversation went back and forth from the tower to patrol. It was evident that the planes were in sight of one another, but all were confused. The last message was received at 4.25 pm. "We are not certain where we are...Think we must be about 225 miles northeast of base...looks like we are..." End of message, the last message from the patrol. The air-sea search which followed was one of the largest ever conducted. Over three hundred planes, ships, and boats of all types, together with ground search parties on the island, combed 280,000 square miles. But nothing was ever found—not even one life vest or single piece of debris! Investigations by scientists of the Bermuda Triangle were carried out in the 1950s by the late Wilbur B. Smith, an electronics expert. Unfortunately the project terminated with his death. He labeled regions such as the ones described as "regions of reduced binding," and claimed to have discovered these atmospheric regions with the aid of an instrument he invented. He stated that such regions were found to exist where there were unexplained air crashes. The regions were circular, up to 1,000 feet in diameter, and probably extended a great distance upward. Smith was quoted as saying that he did not know if these regions moved about, or just faded away. However, he noted that some of these regions had disappeared after three or four months. These regions have also been called "hyperfields" or areas of null-gravity. They may be the first manifestation of an electromagnetic or gravitational vortex that accomplishes two things: One, objects are rendered invisible. Two, conditions are created that make teleportation possible. To where then? To another point on the earth, or to some other time-space continuum, co-existing with our own? Another study of these mysterious areas was made by the U.S. government in a project titled "Project Magnet." The government went to study

the earth's magnetic field, allegedly taking pains to investigate the areas of null-gravity that Smith had noted. Satellites were purportedly sent up to detect and measure changes in the earth's magnetic field. NASA disclaims these satellites, but in November of 1966 an interesting article appeared in the nation's newspapers, originating in the NEW YORK TIMES NEWS SERVICE: "Three unidentified satellites are in orbit about earth...they have not been identified with any launching or country of origin, according to the official catalogue 'SATELLITE SITUATION REPORT.'"

These spots of reduced binding in the earth's magnetic field somehow have the ability to shift objects out of our own time-continuum! The Allende-Jessup case is probably one of the most fascinating puzzles in UFO files. Did the U.S. Navy ever cause a warship and crew to become invisible by somehow utilizing an artificial state of reduced binding? Was the ship accidentally teleported from Philadelphia to its dock near Norfolk, by applying the principles of Einstein's Unified Field Theory? There are those who believe so. (source of article: Stephen Yankee)

* There has been talk of TIME WARPS actually happening. For example to quote a case: Some few years ago, a modern aircraft was flying a course when suddenly it was confronted by an old type of craft of bygone age, a biplane. The two craft swerved to avoid each other. Their wing tips touched. On reporting the incident a search was carried out at ground level for the old bi-plane. One was found in a long abandoned hangar over 50 years old(?) Anyway, a log book entry in the bi-plane read (and was dated at least for that period), that it had a near collision with a strange "silvery aircraft". Now had the old plane gone forward in time or the new craft backwards in time for a brief period? Maybe this could explain some disappearances. I hope for the sake of those now gone that way, that they have been whisked into a parallel time. It would be bad for them to find themselves back in 1966 for example. I have always wondered about death. Could it be that as everything is electrical, when a person departs this world, the electrical counterpart "soul" goes DOWNWARDS into the ground, instead of the assumed UPWARDS. Then the soul drifts through, while shrieking, into another sub-miniature universe where they are born again. There is hypotheses abound to assume that, for example there's (?) another solar system etc INSIDE A BLOCK OF METAL!

When all the data is added up, you must come to one grim conclusion: our planes, ships, automobiles and people are being removed by an alien force, perhaps an alien race, whose origins are totally unknown to us. Statistically, these events tend to cluster around the 10th and 24th of the month year after year, with a disproportionate amount of activity on Wednesdays. These patterns indicate that some form of intelligence is behind it all—but for what purpose?

So ran the headlines of this international magazine SAGA. But perhaps, there are at times, NO intelligence behind the Kidnappings! Maybe these are natural occurrences, as we have just seen. For example, a lone Atlantic rower, had the fright of his life when he was caught unexpectedly in the most fiercest electrical storm he had ever seen, with lightning bolts crashing down around him. It appeared to come and go abruptly. This is a natural occurrence. However CNK will still be looking into this subject in further issues. However there are cases where UFOs have been involved in this. I read somewhere that a Frenchman was walking along when he saw a jet fighter swallowed up suddenly by a UFO. I shall endeavour to find this report and enlarge on it. Can anyone else help? Some of those kidnapped have returned after weeks of absence, with all events wiped out of their memory. Determined to prove the monster is no legend, he quit his job as a manager in London more than three years ago to settle on Loch Ness-side . . . and watch.


Today, on an Army pension and a small investment, he lives in a tent a few feet from the shore.

One of the aims of this group according to UFO NEWS is to "Co-ordinate UFO research on a nationwide scale and CO-OPERATE with persons and organisations engaged upon similar research in all parts of the world." Although to a MINUTE degree this is true, but only when those individuals inside the group WANT something out of you. This is how it looks in my opinion. They do not seem to like it when you WANT something out of them in exchange, like INFORMATION for example! Lionel Beer once editor of Spacelink often spoke out on items in his magazine, and said that this magazine should do the same, when injustice is being done. Those are not exactly his words, but you know what I mean. What CNK accuses BUFORA of is NOT CO-OPERATING on a national level. BUFORA seems like a closed UNION shop, unless you are a member you don't get the information. Now that's not the right attitude for a group whose 'manifesto' tells the above, seems FAR from the truth! Point two is DOES BUFORA REALLY EXIST? Reason: Some people are now saying "BUFORA Doesn't DO anything." Which is not entirely true. In fact BUFORA does DO something, even if others in the group decide to do it in their name, for example organising skywatches. Although organised by BUFORA or some of its members, this year at least, some were very unwilling to leave the comfort of their arm chairs and DO something. In the Essex UFO Study Group's Newsletter, examples of some of BUFORA's "wouldn't care less" members is shown in this summary: "A meeting was to have taken place between I. and B. of BUFORA and Roy Lake, Ron Markwick, Ray Cardwell, Ron Neville and David Prockter. Unfortunately this meeting did not take place as both BUFORA members did not turn up." Also this lack of interest lately in UFOs by BUFORA was summed up in

this year's national skywatch day when BUFORA 'organised' the event but was staffed mainly by the Essex UFO Study Group! CNK also wants to know, along with many others, just what does happen to UFO sighting reports when they are turned in to BUFORA? NO NEWS EVER SEEMS TO COME OUT OF THEM. It all goes into them but never out. Once again lets reiterate their 'manifesto' :- AIMS, to co-ordinate UFO research on a nationwide scale and cooperate with persons and organisations engaged upon similar research. As far as editor's of UFO magazines go, that means an exchange of journals. BUFORA does not exchange theirs, yet they will take yours! Since several copies of CNK are now in the hands of a few BUFORA members. UFO NEWS sums up BUFORA as: Britain's largest group of Ufologists. How then can a responsible society such as BUFORA TOTALLY IGNORE and HELP TO PROMOTE interest in this subject, when the ISTRG UK hold an open air UFO convention at Woburn Abby in 1969?) I think it's about time BUFORA pulled its socks up, and stand by what they claim to be, otherwise, it WILL dwindle, and once again become a collection of small groups scattered all over the country. For heaven's sake let's stop the bickering between groups. Carol Halford Watkins, said on a sound movie I made sometime ago: "Let's unite, let's cooperate, instead of being a wide-spread separate groups." and that is precisely the reason for this article to draw attention to the situation. Maybe BUFORA never knew the situation even existed, as they are still 'working' on the cause. Let's make it together. Or BUFORA one day really won't exist!

ASTRONOMY with GRAHAM SHEPHERD

THE SAGA OF KOHOUTEK COMET. Continued from CNK no.8.

The stage of cometary Research progressed rapidly and further with the discovery of the law of gravitation by Newton, thereby making possible the determination of orbits for the celestial bodies. Subsequently the comets' independence of the solar system were found with their moving round the sun in paths having the form of conic sections. Halley (1656-1742) and Olbers (1758-1840) took advantage of this new tool for cometary prediction and applied extensive research into many comets and the determination of their orbits. A new approach altogether to cometary research had been introduced with celestial mechanics losing their former mysticism, throughout the nineteenth century the practice received continual refinement. Statistical studies succeeded in predicting the returns of short period comets including the establishment of a special set of comets influenced enough by the gravitational effects of the planet Jupiter to be forcibly fall into certain short period orbits. It had been shown comets were members of our solar system through the application of celestial mechanics to comets still and continues to remain inadequate to show whether this has always been the case; whether they originated and were formed with the solar system or added later, thereby introducing the cosmogonical aspect to the treatment of the problem. Research into the physical nature of comets was initiated by Bessel (1784-1846) followed notably by Bredichin (1831-1904). Bredichin was the first to propose a theory of cometary structure and tails, effects of which wholly originated from within the solar system. It was assumed quite validly the diffuse appearance of comets followed with the implication of agglomeration of the smallest particles-atoms. (To be continued)

FIREBALLS

NATURE'S GREATEST MYSTERY



They are usually about a foot long, hot and fiery and like-ly to squeeze under doors, and chase people about their homes.

They are fireballs--or ball-lightning--and their strange behaviour has baffled scientists for years.

Fireballs strike as if they have an independent will.

A few years ago, a housewife at Cheltenham, Gloucestershire, was "chased" by a fireball.

It followed her upstairs and, just as she thought the thing would envelope her, it passed through a window and disappeared with a crash like thunder.

Scientists cannot understand why the phenomenon so often appears in houses. Fireballs have been known to contract, pass through a keyhole and expand the other side. Ron Markwick, an investigator into Fireballs said that being a form of corpuscular energy, like all types of electricity, they may take the path of the least resistance, ie. Keyhole.

They have also flattened and slipped under doors.

French scientists recorded a case of a fireball which entered a house, exploded and killed a kitten sitting on a girl's lap, but did not injure the child.

Another singed the pyjamas of a woman lying in bed.

Ball-lightning has been sighted all over the world. Dr. Alexander Russel, a British scientist, reported seeing two fireballs. One, he said struck a building and burst with a loud bang.

In Kansas City, a few years ago, a woman saw an object about 2ft. long dart into her room. It hovered and took on the shape of a ball.

Then it dissolved with a sound like breaking glass.

Ball-lightning has injured few people and only one death has been reported. This happened when a Russian scientist was flying a kite in an experiment. A fireball is believed to have rolled down the kite rope and electrocuted him. (source: WEEKEND (?))
