THE ZANFRETTE CASE

The following account of a series of abductions in Northern Italy was submitted for publication by Marco Raffa of Lavagna, who is Director of the UFO Group S.H.A.D.O. Italy.

The first act in this series of sightings and dramatic events began on the evening of December 6, 1978.

Fortunato Zanfretta (called "Piero"), a private security guard, was going about his normal duty near the small town of Torriglia on the hinterland of Genoa. Zanfretta, 26, is known by his friends and colleagues to be a courageous and honest man.

At 11.30 p.m. he was outside a small house called "Villa Casa Nostra" when he saw, in the garden, about 100 metres away, four lights. Zanfretta believed at first that they were flashlights belonging to thieves, so, being inside his patrol car, he placed a call over the radio to his security division (Vigilanza Valbisagno) stationed in Genoa. However, while in the act of calling, the engine, lights and radio cut out for no apparent reason. Zanfretta then reached for his own flashlight and gun, got out of the car and walked towards the place where he had seen the four lights. While he was walking, however, the lights moved behind the house, and when Zanfretta arrived on the scene he consequently thought that the thieves had also moved behind the house. So, being a cautious man, Zanfretta lay in wait in order to surprise them when they came back.

Suddenly, to Zanfretta's amazement, he felt something touching his back, and upon turning around was astonished to see a sort of "trunk", which he at first described as dark grey in colour and with strange "undulations" all over it. Zanfretta then lifted his gaze and with the aid of the flashlight saw an "ugly, frightful face." At that same moment as the flashlight illuminated the 'face' of the being the flashlight switched off of its own accord. Terrorized, Zanfretta dropped the flashlight, which upon hitting the ground came back on. As he stooped down to pick it up he believed that the strange being was moving away. Likewise, Zanfretta did the same and began to run back to his car. He then noticed a brilliant light rising upwards behind him, and upon turning saw an enormous triangular-shaped light taking off from the back of the house, the light quickly disappearing.

Returning to his car, Zanfretta once again called his division and this time everything was operating normally: the time was now 11.50 p.m.

Zanfretta's disconnected sentences as he conversed with his division convinced his colleagues that he was in trouble, and so patrol cars were sent out to help him.

When, at about 1.00 a.m. on December 7, the cars reached the scene of the trouble, Zanfretta's colleagues found him about 100 metres from his car and realized that he was clearly in shock. With gun in one hand and flashlight in the other, Zanfretta was found lying face down on the ground in a field near the house.

For two days the affair remained a secret, and while carrying out an investigation the police discovered two tracks on the ground behind the house. Their shape was like that of a horseshoe and of about 2.50 metres in diameter - the same as other tracks discovered in Southern Italy four days after Zanfretta's encounter. These other tracks were found following a sighting reported by civilians and policemen at Barletta (Puglia).

No-one knew anything about Zanfretta's case until the publication of an article on December 8 by Genoa's "Il Secolo XIX" newspaper. On the morning of the same day our Group tried to contact other Genoan ufologists, but unfortunately they were all absent having attended a meeting with Prof. Bino Bini, Director of the Astronomical Observatory of Imperia. So, considering the importance of the case, we contacted our Piedmont colleagues - Edoardo Russo of "CLYPEUS" and Darop Camurri of "Centro Ufologico Nazionale" in Turin - with whom we went to Genoa and interviewed Zanfretta and his colleagues for about an hour. The interview took place at their headquarters, "Vigilanza Valbisagno", and the account given here is based on what we were told.

While interviewing Zanfretta we asked him if he would object to hypnotic regression, for in many cases of UFO sightings the entire story has been confirmed by such experiments with only a small probability of falsehood. However, our witness wasn't too happy with this idea, but he did promise that if his physical and psychological condition subsequent to the shock of the encounter didn't improve, he would submit to the hypnosis. In fact, only a few days later, Zanfretta agreed to the hypnosis session under Prof. Mauro Moretti, Director of the Medical Hypnosis Centre in Genoa, and member of the Italian Association of Medical Hypnosis. Dr. Luciano Boccone, our Arenzana colleague, who was among those present at the session, told us that the report given by Zanfretta under hypnosis was about the same as that given while in his fully conscious state, but with some additional peculiarities. Besides the encounter near the house, Zanfretta had also been abducted by the strange being! He described being brought into a place which was "very light and hot," where the being, together with other companions, began to interrogate him. Zanfretta described the beings as very tall - about three metres - and having dark green skin (before hypnosis he described it as dark grey, but it's likely that this was only recalled during the hypnotic session). The bodies of the beings were described in rather more detail by the witness than in the former interview, and for this description we return in the story to Zanfretta's first contact with the being at about 11.35 p.m. on December 6:-

Zanfretta turned around to see who had touched him, and while turning he knocked his peak against something, which at that moment was illuminated with the flashlight. Visible was what seemed to be a mass of large, horizontal tubes, dark grey in colour. Lifting his flashlight still further, Zanfretta illuminated, at a height of about three metres, the 'face' of the being. He (or 'it'?) had those strange dark tubes all over his body, while his head, which was dark green in colour, was rather large being about 60 cm. in width. Two dreadful eyes, yellow, radiant and triangular in shape, stood out on the being's face and were inclined upwards, while on the forehead there was something indefinable and yellow in colour - like an eye - surmounted by great, irregular wrinkles. Instead of hair, these beings had "big, pointed thorns" all over their heads, and two ears or "horns" turned upwards and pointed.

Then the story continues as described in our first interview, but there are yet further strange happenings; in fact, Zanfretta added to his story a further experience which he couldn't recall while conscious. This experience can effectively fill the 'vacuum of time', otherwise unaccountable for, of the famous distance of 100 metres run in 18 minutes!

In brief, the witness expressed - still under the hypnotic state - firstly his fear in front of these "unknown, monstrous beings," and his reluctance to follow them. In fact, going by Zanfretta's story, the beings wanted to take him "elsewhere" against his will, and under hypnosis it was evident that he was totally subordinate to the will of his kidnapers.

From the evidence given under deep hypnosis, unknown equipment was used upon Zanfretta in order to prevent him moving or looking around, and for transmitting messages and concepts to him. At the same time it was apparent from the witness' anxiety that he wished to know who or what was touching and manipulating him, but it was equally obvious that he knew his captors were of a non-human nature. Zanfretta expressed his wish to return home and desired an end to the suffering caused him by the thing on his head - to say nothing of the dazzling light which hurt his eyes and the stifling heat in which he was immersed.


Because of the witness' condition, Dr. Moretti decided to end the session without going into the events that occurred during the second part of the experience that was concluded between 00.16 and 01.06 on December 7, 1978.

Regarding these events, Zanfretta's report was very brief. However, he confirmed the story narrated while conscious and also the report by his colleagues. (This is a piece of our friend Luciana Boccone's report on the hypnosis of Dec.23). The case now seemed closed, but suddenly a new fact, possibly more strange than the first, occurred.

Zanfretta, following some days of shock, wished to carry on his work as normal, and on the night of December 26 at about 11.45 p.m. he was driving his Fiat 127 - property of Valbisagno - along the "Galleria (tunnel) of Bargagli", very near the location of the previous encounter, when he suddenly lost all control of the car. Incredibly, the car turned around and came out of the tunnel and continued on its own course, while Zanfretta, terrorised, tried to brake and steer but in vain as all the controls were overridden. The car continued along a road that leads to a place called Rossi, the road in question being considerably uphill. After about 2 km., though, the car braked suddenly and Zanfretta was thrown forward knocking his head against the windscreen. The story then repeats itself.....

Zanfretta's colleagues reached the place after a call over the car radio at 01.10 a.m. on December 27 by our witness, but the first man to find the unfortunate security guard was a Sgt. Travenzoli, a military officer of the Italian Government police (Carabinieri).

Zanfretta had told Sgt. Travenzoli, although with rather disconnected sentences and words, a lot of interesting facts, but when members of Zanfretta's security division arrived he had quite forgotten everything and was still in shock.

Near the place of the encounter, two strange tracks were discovered which had the shape of a big shoe, or more that of a climbing boot, and of 50cm. length and 20cm. width. The tracks had a distinct empty space between heel and sole. The place round about is uninhabited and the road leading to it a lonely one, and only a restricted number of people knew that here was the scene of Zanfretta's encounter; no newspaper had reported the exact place, either.

During an on-the-spot investigation carried out in February, about two months after the event, we found the tracks quite unimpaired, but although rain and snow had lightly damaged them they were still clearly visible. This was only due to the fact, we felt, that the place had remained undisclosed. The same couldn't be said, however, about the area where Zanfretta had had his first encounter, for it had become a place of pilgrimage by tourists, journalists and the curious. The December 10, 1978 edition of "Il Secolo XIX" published an article that (translated) read: "UFOs at Torriglia bring good luck: now the village has been invaded by tourists."

Our colleague Roberto Balbi, Director of Genoa's Centro Ufologico Nazionale Section, discovered a new fact after talking to Zanfretta's division. Apparently, when Zanfretta had his recent second encounter the weather was bad - rain and fog - but when members of the security division found both car and witness they discovered that the car was very hot, as though it had been left for "an entire day under the Sun." The heat was localised on the roof and precisely over the driver's seat, but the inside was hot also and it felt like "the inside of an oven." Zanfretta, who was found in a field near his car with a gun in one hand, was also bone dry and had a warm head. This is peculiar because both car and Zanfretta had been out in heavy rain for hours.

Surprisingly, the newspapers took little notice of the second encounter, and it's possible there was a damper imposed by someone who wished to prevent further interest being taken in this case.

A few days later, we were informed that a second hypnotic session had been carried out on Zanfretta and a private TV company in Genoa (TWS), which is connected with the publication "Il Secondo XIX", had videorecorded the entire affair. The experience was very moving to watch, and it was then that we fully realised - listening to Zanfretta's words - that his experiences were real. No transcription can render the sensation of truth and honesty that Zanfretta's hypnotic account revealed. At times his story was disconnected, and some phrases seemed to belong to the sci-fi world:-

"I know that you need me, but.....I won't.....I want to remain with my sonsNo.....! I won't come with you.....! What do you want from me.....? I'm not

able to answer your questions.....! I'm not the qualified person you need.....
Why are you undressing me.....? I won't.....No.....this thing on my head,
no, ... it's hurting me.....! I'm hot; here there's a stifling heat..... Why do
you call me with that whistle.....?

You're monstrous, all dark green, tall.....I'm afraid..... You're not like
us.....you're not human.....Why do your fingers end with these suckers.....?

Please, take off this thing from my head, it's pressing on my head, it's
hurting me.....

Do you come from far off.....? (and presumably after their answer) No....
No.....! I won't follow you to your planet..... You tell me that next time you'll
take me away..... I won't.....! I'm alright here with my wife and my sons.....
Go away.....!"

This is just a part of Zanfretta's dialogue with the beings, and the entire
session gave us a good idea of their malevolent thoughts and actions.

Besides the shock created by the two encounters, Zanfretta had also had
great problems with his work caused by the negative publicity following the
experiences. Why, though, should such a courageous man with a wife and two small
sons make up such an incredible story, from which he had gained nothing and instead
had lost his job and reported being in shock? During a meeting with friends and
ufologists, Zanfretta reinforced his situation by stating, "If I had been able to
foresee the consequences, I wouldn't have reported my experience....."

The last act of this exceptional UFO adventure occurred at Milan on February
6, 1979, when Zanfretta submitted to another session of hypnotic regression, this
time by Prof. Marco Marchesan at the headquarters of the International Centre of
Medical and Psychological Hypnosis. Prof. Marchesan is a member of the Union des
Associations Internationales and the World Federation for Mental Health, and is
deemed as one of the most experienced Italian hypnotists.

During this particular session, the well-known truth serum "Pentothal" was
administered, and some new incredible facts came to light, but unfortunately we
cannot speak of these facts because of the lawful secrecy which is attached to
this hypnotic session. However, from the (secret) account of our colleague
Luciano Boccone, we can say but two things: first, the medical and scientific
administration are agreed as to the reliability of the witness' account under
Pentothal - assisted hypnosis, there being a 90% probability of the account being
true, and 10% that it is an unconscious suggestion. In any case, the experts
discounted a deliberate lie. Second, and perhaps the most intriguing point, is
that during hypnosis, Zanfretta confirmed something mentioned during a previous
hypnotic session, which the beings conveyed to him via telepathic suggestions,
and this was the presage of a third and decisive act in this one man's series of
adventures.

What will this third act consist of? Perhaps a new and final abduction,
this time without Zanfretta's return?

We lie in wait.....

3rd FESTIVAL for MIND-BODY-SPIRIT
held at Olympia, London, April 21-29, 1979.

A brief report by the editor

Not having been to previous Festivals of this nature at Olympia, I decided
that I'd have to get along to this year's just to see what I'd been missing out on.

Since I had decided to go on the first day of opening, the queue outside the

hall at mid-day was, as to be expected, considerable, but the delay there was well worthwhile for the Festival was everything that I had envisaged it to be. Inside there were stands catering for just about every relevant subject you could think of, and a few more besides!

In order not to miss anything amongst the vast multitude present, I decided to make my way around the stands at the hall's perimeter before wandering among the more centrally placed exhibits, and, later, the first floor's offerings.

Exhibitors - According to the programme there were some 176 exhibitors present, and, although I'd like to list them all, for the purposes of a not-too-lengthy report I'll just give some of the more important/interesting subjects under their collective headings.

ESOTERIC:- The Aetherius Society, Atlanteans, Prediction Magazine, Viewpoint Aquarius, The International Assoc'n. of Colour Healers, Rosicrucian Order (AMORC), The White Eagle Lodge.

HEALTH & HEALING:- The College of Acupuncture, Homeopathic Herbal Store, Lotus Foods, Vegan Society, The Vegetarian Society, Uvasun, Sabona Rheumatic Relief Ltd.

HUMAN POTENTIAL:- Biomate (UK) Ltd. and Pyramid Energy Products, Grand Order of Water Rats, The Ockendon Venture, The Samaritans.

SPIRITUALITY:- Atlantis, The British Wheel of Yoga, The Grail Foundation of Great Britain, Raja Yoga Centre, The Order of the Cross, The Catholic Study Circle for Animal Welfare Journal "The Ark".

ARTS:- Miracles, Mandalas of Creation, Earthfolke, Hindukush, Spectrum Research Institute.

ECOLOGY:- Beauty Without Cruelty Ltd., Earthlore, Ecology Party/Ecologist, Friends of the Earth Ltd., Green Farm, The Humane Research Trust, Hunt Saboteurs Assoc'n., The National Anti-Vivisection Society, The Hunger Project, The Humane Education Council.

GENERAL:- Fontana Paperbacks, Sphere Books, Thorsons Publishers Ltd., Transworld Publishers, etc.

I feel that it goes without saying that many of those organisations listed under ECOLOGY & HUMAN POTENTIAL are truly worthy of everyone's praise. Personally, I was delighted to see the enthusiasm shown by those representing such organisations, considering the formidable obstacles they all face.

A few stands in particular seemed to arouse much interest, the two that I noticed being for Kirlian Aura Diagnosis and Tarot card/palm reading. The biggest crowd-puller, however, was the floor show from Dancercise - dancing to keep fit!

Although being UFO orientated, there wasn't, I discovered too much in the way of UFO exhibitors, the only two examples there - and UFOs formed only a part of their displays - were Viewpoint Aquarius (V.A.) and the Aetherius Society. Actually I had hoped to have a few words with V.A.'s Rex Dutta, but I wasn't able to locate him; neither was I able to locate Sir John Whitmore, who has spent a fortune looking into the psychic world, an area, I feel, very important in ufology.

My main port of call was, in fact, to The Aetherius Society, about whose aims and ideas I had heard many derogatory comments. The stand they occupied was, I thought, one of the best at the Festival and on display were books, recordings, and a large selection of health foods and pharmaceutical creams(?) - to say nothing of various videorecorded programmes, which naturally attracted a great deal of interest. According to a woman representative I spoke to who had joined as a healer and was, in herself, quite genuine, they all follow one man - George King - who they feel is closer to God than any of them because of his contact with (among others) a space-being called Aetherius who passes over messages of vital importance to the world.

After a lengthy discussion I came to the conclusion that although I would not dismiss the possibility of George King being a contactee and a channel for other intelligencies, I do feel that a certain amount of egoism and false ideas this 'end' have earned the Society the disrepute they sadly now have.

Although, as already stated, there was a lack of UFO exhibitors, I found the majority of the remaining exhibits extremely interesting, but in order to appreciate this once-a-year gathering of the (mainly) unusual necessitated letting my mind 'expand' much more than usual: trying to retain a scientific mind here was very inhibitive (the same problem, I feel, that faces ufology). I can only end this report by hoping that a 4th Festival will be staged for next year.

"U.F.O's"- by Terry Thomas

Until recent years, the question of whether or not UFO's truly existed was a common one; today, however, all serious seekers know they positively do exist, and even the governments of most countries accept this fact.

Whilst I agree that some time and effort must still be spared to answer the questions of new seekers, the time has come for serious minded people to stop their time wastage in idle UFO spotting and use their efforts to first search for the truth about our space visitors and then use the knowledge they find to benefit our planet. The fifty thousand dollar question, however, is who are we to believe, as almost daily more and more people are claiming that they have been visited and told conflicting information by our space visitors, and we must remember that there have always been false prophets, and wolves who speak with a lamb's tongue, in order to give themselves false prestige.

We all have what is commonly referred to as 'common sense' and if we use it to analyse the truth we find from the lies, we will very quickly ascertain the truth about UFOs, and, in doing so, will realise the significance of them to us and our planet.

In the beginning there was, as there always will be, energy, and as there cannot be good without evil, there was, and still is, good and evil energy. The good we call God and the evil the Devil, and continually, each tried to convert the other to their way. All planets, every human, animal and plant is constructed of energy. In the beginning on our planet, it was, as it is on all planets, that some of us were first constructed of pure good energy, whilst others were likewise constructed solely of evil energy, with these energy forms continuing their parent's fight to convert the other to their way. A fight that still continues today. Under the laws of the Universe, these energy bodies merged to give birth to new energy bodies, a method of creation we still obey on Earth today. At first, good only merged with good and likewise evil with evil, but eventually with the passing of time they merged with each other, creating in their children a conflict of both energies, a conflict we today call our conscience.

With still further passing of time, these energy bodies recharged their energy off the planet's physical energy plant life and also consumed each other in their fight for survival. This made them lose their invisibleness their energy had afforded them, and firstly took on a form of ectoplasm, to later become fully physical, with some of them losing their ability to fly and others even their ability to live on the land. Thus, the species of the land, sea and air were first created, with a species of animal, as history tells us, first becoming those of the cave age, to then develop into the so called civilised race we pride ourselves we are today. One may well imagine that with a nuclear war, only the countries at war would be destroyed. This, however, is not the case and in fact it need not even take a nuclear war to destroy us, but only the testing of one too many nuclear bombs, which could crack the crust of our planet and release the masses of molten lava and atoms harnessed in our planet's core. This would result in worldwide earthquakes and the like, which in three short days would make our planet a burning molten mass, as Venus, despite its thousands of years of cooling, still to a degree is today, after its last human destruction.

When Earth cooled after we last destroyed it, our parent planet, again, in its love and compassion for us, its children and child planet, as all planets like people have parents, sent down volunteers of its people in convoys of space craft to make our planet again habitable. For six thousand years they then toiled at much sacrifice to themselves rebuilding our planet into once again a planet of vegetation, which is stated in the old translation of the Bible as taking six days, and in the new Bible's version as six periods of time. For the seventh period of time, same being again possibly a thousand years, they rested, whilst the vegetation they had planted grew and multiplied. If one seeks, much proof is found of this and other facts in the Great Pyramid of Cheops, and the coal we burn on our fires, being but a few.

To fully explain the proof which coal gives us that our planet has been previously destroyed, take for example the fossils of the many ferns which are found, some 12 inches plus high, in full leaf, besides trees in full bloom. If these were covered by a natural process of decaying vegetation, as taught in our schools, it would take thousands or millions of years, yet these are found as described above all over the world. The life of a fern is only a few months, how then could they become fossilised in the way we have been told? Fossilisation must be an instant process, which in the case of coal fossils could only have been accomplished by instant eruption of our planet's surface, burying fully such vegetation.

Regarding the pyramid of Cheops, our parent planet built this on Earth for three main reasons. One was because they had to have a vast energy store to enable them to seal the main crack in our planet's crust, and they built the pyramid over this crack to do so. The second reason was because they also needed the energy the pyramid harnessed to work their plant and machinery to make our barren rock into fertile soil and to facilitate this, many smaller pyramids were built all over our planet, but as their use was only temporary, they were not constructed to last (although many still remain) and thus disintegrated long before mankind became an intelligent race. The third reason was that the Cheops pyramid, owing to its position on our planet and in the Universe, was their communication centre with their own planet and their work forces on our planet, together with it being their main depot on Earth. Their work of rebuilding our planet completed, the space craft of our parent planet returned to their home, but every so often throughout the ages there have been reports by historic drawings etc., of their visits, including many mentions of such in the Bible. The process of mankind's physical and spiritual evolution then took over and by obeying the laws of the Universe of 'Karma' and 'Reincarnation', the human race progressed from pure energy to our present existence.

Every 5,000 years or so a major service is undertaken on the Earth's fault lines, and at present such a service is being undertaken by our parent planet, which is why there have been so many sightings of space craft in recent years. (This traffic of space craft is even more increased at this present time because Earth is once again at the end of its present cycle of evolution and we must decide again whether or not to destroy ourselves or proceed to become ourselves a parent planet. There are many higher stages of evolution than we on Earth have attained, on many other planets. Together, of course, with many planets on a lower stage of evolution than us. These planets on a higher level than us, also consist of both good and evil, and the fight for control of the younger planets such as Earth is a constant one. We on Earth could still become one of the evil planets, and in their fight to win us there are many space craft from the evil planets waiting to invade us, should they see that their evil souls on Earth are losing their battle for our control. In fact, they would have invaded us some years ago, but have been prevented from doing so by the strong armada of space ships that our parent planet now have constantly patrolling Earth, as again, being good parents, they will defend their child planet Earth until we are able to do so ourselves, or with our freedom of choice, choose evil as our masters.

By formulating the energy within and around us all, each and every one of us can do great things to help our planet to this time succeed, instead of destroying ourselves, and in doing so make our planet truly a place of peace, that will not only benefit our children, but ourselves, as it must be remembered that we have all reincarnated many times to reap what we have sown in our previous lives, and we will again reincarnate to reap what we sow in this life. I am really sorry that space does not enable me to explain how you can formulate energy, but such knowledge is readily available to all those who request it.

UFO LANDS ON PET FARM

11.20 p.m., May 28 (approx), 1978.

Introduction - Mr. Bill Eden, an investigator working in the Chelmsford, Essex area, first heard about this case whilst driving to work listening to the car radio on January 9, 1979, and wondered if the object described by the witness could have been a helicopter. A few days later he received a phone call from the East Essex Gazette newspaper, and during the conversation, which was about UFO reports, the above witness' name, address and phone no. were passed over to Mr. Eden. An interview subsequently took place on January 28, 1979.

Bill Eden's Report

Mr. Peter Duncan, 42, and his wife manage a pet farm at Weeley, near Clacton-on-Sea, Essex, their farm lying immediately south of a railway which runs approx. E to W. The Duncans own some 33 cats, 55 dogs, 7 or 8 horses, numerous budgerigars and other animals, and their working day starts early and finishes around 6.00 p.m.

On the day of the sighting Mr. Duncan had been constructing some new kennels near the stables (see plan drawing) and didn't finish work until about 11.20 p.m. He then went back to the house, and at about 11.20 p.m. made his way around the area for a final check on the animals. After checking the kennels he walked back towards the house, but when he was about level with the food store he noticed the trees behind the office building had suddenly become illuminated by a white light, which was accompanied by a droning noise. The noise was heavy but not loud and no-one else heard it. (Mr. Duncan commented that he wouldn't have heard it himself if he had been inside a building with the door shut.) After standing there for a few minutes pondering the situation he decided to go over to the five acre field where he kept the horses and from where the light and noise seemed to emanate. When asked why he hesitated for a few minutes he admitted, a little reluctantly, that he was afraid of the dark. The oven near the food store was not in darkness because it was lit up by the infra-red lighting which keeps the animals warm at night. The horse field, however, was in darkness apart from the unknown light source.

Mr. Duncan made his way slowly over towards the field - about 225 yds (206m.) away - while the droning noise, which he described as being like that of a WWII 'buzz-bomb', still filled his ears. Nearing the end of the row of kennels to his right he could see, around the stables beyond them, a bright white light about 9 or 10ft. (2.7-3m.) down from the top of the power-line pole in the middle of the field. The pole is 20 to 25ft high (6.1-7.6m.) and the light was just to the right of it, and from the drawing made by his wife following his description of the object, I would say that the light was 2 or 3ft. (.6- .9m.) in diameter.

Believing that he was watching a helicopter land in the field, Mr. Duncan carried on walking to obtain a better view of things and no doubt enquire just what was going on, for this was private property. Then, a little further on, a second light came into view as the stables fell away to his right. This other light was the same as the first and about 75 to 80ft. (23-24.4m.) to the right (measured by pacing out the distance); it was also about the same height above the ground. Even with these two lights and the noise, he still believed that he was watching a helicopter, but as his eyes became accustomed to the darkness he began to see more, and it was then that he realised it was definitely not a helicopter he was looking at and began to get rather frightened. By this time he had climbed over the fence surrounding the field and was, I estimated, standing only some 60 yds (55m.) from the object, and that was where he stopped. The horses were nowhere to be seen, but the lights on the object made it difficult for him to see anything else. Mr. Duncan stood and watched wondering what the object could have been although he felt, somehow, that it was not of this world. He said he would not forget it for a long time.

The Object - Whatever it was it seemed to be resting on the ground and was in the order of 20 to 25ft. (6.1-7.6m.) high and 85 to 90ft. (26-27.4m) across. The thing was made up in three sections. The top section had the shape of a dome similar to the head of a button mushroom. The centre section was that of a tube whose diameter was four times its length but slightly wider at the bottom than at the top. In this section there were four horizontal window-like slits, two on each side of what appeared to be a door with a walled ramp leading down to ground level.

The two bright lights were situated one either side of the centre section and the top of this 'tube' seemed to be fitted into the underside of the domed section. The lower section was like that of a skirt which to me is similar to the surround at the bottom of a German WWII helmet. The whole body was dull grey or silver in colour.

After five or six minutes Mr. Duncan lifted his torch in an attempt to see into the slits or the door-way, which were in total darkness. As he did this, however, the object lifted off the ground, moved slowly up and over towards the railway, hovered for a few seconds and then moved off at high speed towards the S.E. He did not notice, however, if the ramp was retracted after take-off.

Even though eight months had elapsed since the sighting, I went to the field in question with Mr. Duncan to check for marks and take measurements. Finding no marks I asked Mr. Duncan if he had checked for marks since the sighting, but he said he hadn't for it had not occurred to him to do so because at the time he felt a bit ridiculous about the whole affair. Previous to this sighting he had never believed in UFOs.

Apart from the horses, which were all found again in the morning, no other animals showed any indication of their awareness of the object.

Mr. Duncan seemed quite ordinary, genuine and of average intelligence, and desired minimal publicity (a hoax is very unlikely here). The delay in reporting the sighting was because of his belief that the story would not be accepted, but when he saw the TV report on the New Zealand UFOs of New Year's Eve, etc., he was spurred into reporting what he saw to CONTACT (UK), who then informed the BBC and the East Essex Gazette. BBC Radio 4 then broadcast their taped telephone conversation with Mr. Duncan. The only peculiarity in this case is that although desiring no real publicity, Mr. Duncan did not seem very concerned about his anonymity as his name was widely published, (he also spoke to Radio Orwell). Perhaps he has little ability to preserve his identity once approached. Finally, the possibility of hallucination obviously exists with a one-person sighting, but is a possibility impossible to answer in this case without a qualified person knowledgeable in this field.

As far as a helicopter being the mystery object, there seems little doubt that this could have been the case for there was no air turbulence when it took off. Of interest, Mr. Duncan said that he felt he would see this UFO, or more of them, again as he dreamt recently of many UFOs passing over his pet farm. Since the sighting he has been very dubious about being near the 'landing area' at night, and his wife says that she has heard humming noises at night on various occasions; Mr. Duncan feels these may have a connection with UFOs.

Apart from Mr. Duncan's TV playing up a little on the evening of the sighting, there have been no other noteworthy happenings since.

THE WINGED BEINGS OF BLUESTONE WALK

The following is the true story, as told in the words of the witness, Mrs. Jean Hingley, of an encounter with beings from another world.

Our thanks for this story go to Mrs. E. Morris of Dudley, West Midlands, who interviewed Mrs. Hingley on numerous occasions and presented us with this very strange but charming account. Grateful thanks also to Mrs. Morris for her delightful drawings illustrating this case, from Mrs. Hingley's descriptions.

"On the morning of January 4th 1979, I had the strangest experience of my whole life.

I live in a small Council house at Rowley Regis near Birmingham. The house is one of a number on a small estate surrounded by waste land and quarries. We have lived here for nine years, my husband Cyril and myself. We have an Alsatian dog, Hobo, who is two and a half years old.

I work at a factory making sound-proofing for cars and my husband is employed at a cement works.

The house has a small back garden about seventeen feet by eleven feet with a carport and a shed at the end of the garden. A door leads out of the back garden to

a parking space. There is a lawn and a pedestrian walk at the front of the house.

At the time this happened it was seven o'clock in the morning on January 4th, and my husband was going off to work by car. I stood at the back door to wave him off. There was no wind blowing and no stars to be seen. It was very cold and dark and there was snow on the ground. Hobo, our dog, was by my side.

When my husband had gone I saw a light in the garden and thought, "Cyril has left the light on in the carport." I went out with the dog and looked in the carport but saw that the light was switched off.

As we turned to go back to the house I saw an orange light over the garden which gradually turned white. We went in the back door into the kitchen. I left the door open and put the dish down for Hobo to drink his water. Then I said, "What's the matter, Hobo?" He looked so queer. All his hair was sticking out like a hedgehog's. It seemed to be stiff and the hairs were like needles. He seemed to hobble into the hall swaying from side to side. You know how a dog usually turns round before he settles down, well he just flopped down and lay stiff with his eyes glaring as though he had been drugged. Yet usually Hobo is afraid of nothing.


I was standing by the sink and suddenly I heard three sounds come past me..... zee.....zee.....zee...and three slim silvery green beings with rainbow wings floated past me through the open door into the lounge.

I was terrified. I clung on to the sink and thought, "What's happening?" Believe me or not, I couldn't move. I was stunned. All the blood seemed to leave my face and I felt as though all the blood in my body had run out of my toes. I was paralysed. I couldn't move or speak.

I had my hands on the sink. Suddenly they were moved. I floated towards the lounge. I had my hand on the door but my feet didn't touch the floor. There was a brilliant light. I could hear the little green and silver artificial tree, the Christmas tree, shaking and rattling as the ornaments were shaken. I couldn't believe it was happening to me. I went to say, "Hello! Hello!" My mouth was open but no words came out. My eyes were moving but my head was stiff. It was strange. It was a bitterly cold morning and the doors were open but I felt warm. I felt as though I was in heaven although I was at home.


I saw the three 'beings' in the lounge. They were shaking the Christmas tree and the ornaments were rattling and the little fairy fell off the top. I couldn't move to pick it up. I had to cover my eyes as the creatures were so brilliant. They seemed to read my mind. It was like a light or an X-ray penetrating my mind. When I took my hands from my eyes they seemed to have turned down the light. I could see them clearly then. They were about three feet six inches to four feet high. Three very slim little men. Each had a transparent 'fish bowl' helmet over his head and resting on his shoulders. Their faces were waxy white and their eyes were like oblong slits shining like 'black diamonds'. I don't know much about precious stones but that is how they looked to me. They had very thin mouths and there were no ears or eyebrows to be seen. They wore silver balaclava helmets and there was something like a lamp on the top of each helmet. They were wearing silvery-green tunics and silver waistcoats with silver buttons or press studs. Their pointed hands and feet were covered in the same silvery-green material and there was no flesh to be seen. There were silver 'foil' streamers hanging down the front of each one from shoulders to feet.

Their wings were marvellous. They were very large and oval shaped, transparent and very fine like gossamer or the silk round a cocoon. The wings were covered in pinholes or 'braille dots' and all the dots were glowing with gold and rainbow colours - red, green, violet and blue, but more beautiful than our earthly colours. I thought of Joseph's coat of many colours. Our colours seemed 'chemical' in comparison. The three 'beings' were floating about a foot above the floor and they were touching everything. They were touching the furniture and the clock and the radio and the tapes on the sideboard. They looked at the Christmas cards and the pictures on the walls. At last I could speak. I said, "Three of you and one of me. What are you going to do? What do you want with me?" They all spoke together. As they started to speak they pressed their chests with their pointed hands and seemed to manipulate the buttons on their tunics. A 'bleep' sound came before the voice and then they said, with voices coming from their chests, "We shall not harm you." Their mouths never moved.




Key to above: 1.Front garden 2.Front door 3.Lounge door 4.Stairs

 Probably non-luminous while in the garden.

I said, "Where have you come from?" and they said, "We have come from the sky." Just as the first time the voice came from the chest after the 'bleep' sound and the mouths didn't move.

My eyes felt sore from the bright light but I felt happy with them. They looked at me with friendly eyes I thought. I said, "I can't call you creatures. I shall call you 'gentlemen'." I started to say, "Nice to see you," then I said it the way Bruce Forsyth does on television, "Nice to see you. Nice," and they said, "Nice."

They were tugging at the Christmas tree again and I said, "We put up a tree at this time of year because we believe it was the birthday of Jesus." They said, "We know all about Jesus." I said, "What is he like now? I think he was about thirty six when he died but that was along time ago. Has he grown older?" They said, "He is still about thirty six." I said, "Does he look like the picture, 'Behold I stand at the Door and Knock'?" They said, "Yes."

They were floating horizontally over the table and seemed to be looking at the newspapers. On the front page of one paper there was an honours list and Tommy Steele was one of the names on the list. I said, "He has been made a lord." They said together again - the voices coming from their chests - "There is only one Lord." That sounded beautiful I thought.

They were looking at a picture of the Queen. I said, "That is the Queen. You should go to see her. There are some people with plenty of money. You could go to see a real lady." I thought I was an ordinary person. Why come to me? They said, "You are a lady."

Each time they spoke the 'bleep' sound came as they pressed their chests and moved the buttons with their little pointed hands crossed on their chests.

The lights were still on downstairs and I said to them, "Do you have electricity in your world?" and they said, "No."

We have a large corner couch in the lounge and they went over to that and bounced on it like children. I said, "Be careful of my furniture," and they stopped. (At one point the three of them were seated on the couch and the one in the middle, according to Mrs. Hingley, seemed to have his head to one side as though he was tired, but his friend to his right nudged him to sit up straight!) When I spoke sharply they put the light up. They seemed to be able to control the light around them and could make it brighter or dim it. Each pair of their tunics' buttons seemed to operate something: the top ones to increase or decrease the light from the lamps; the second ones the voice; and the third one (I think) the wings. I thought I had better be friendly with them. They were only small but they seemed to have power in their bodies that might have harmed me.

When they floated about the room their wings fluttered gently. There was no sound. When they moved through the open door to the hall they folded their wings behind them like pleated fans. They circled in the hall and then floated upstairs. The doors to the upstairs rooms were closed and they floated down again.

They looked at the bottles of whiskey and sherry on the sideboard. We have some in the house at Christmas and New Year for visitors. I said, "Would you like a drink?" They said, "Water," three times. I went to the kitchen and fetched four glasses of water on a metal tray. I thought I would bring one for myself as well, to show it wasn't poisoned and to keep them company. As I came near them with the metal tray it was as much as I could do to hold it. The tray seemed to be magnetised towards them. Each of them lifted a glass as I lifted mine. They seemed about to lift their masks but when they saw me watching them they put the 'power light' on. I didn't actually see them drink the water but the glasses were empty when they put them down.

I asked them if they had been here before and they said, "Yes." They also said, "We shall come again." I asked them where else they had been. They said, "We have been to Australia, New Zealand and America." They said, "We come down here to talk to people but they don't seem to be interested." I said, "Shall I tell people on Earth about it?" (I don't know why I said "people on Earth" to them). They said, "Yes. Tell people about us." They said to me, "Everyone will go to heaven." I said, "Even the bad people?" They said, "Yes, everyone will go to heaven and the colours there are beautiful."

They seemed to put a light on me to draw out the words they wanted to hear. I was stuttering with nervousness.

I was talking about politics and about women going to work. I said, "It's a man's world," and they said, "Yes, it is." I said there were a lot of bad people in the world and they said, "Yes," and they seemed interested and excited as though they were listening and understanding.

I told them I had not been to chapel for a year or two as chapels had pop groups and guitarists now and I didn't like that kind of service. They said, "There is no need to worship in synagogues." I didn't know what that word meant until my husband said it was the Jewish place of worship. I said the Bible was hard to understand and they seemed to know what I meant. I had the modern Bible on the table and they said, "The old Bible is the right one. Not the new version."

I told them that I had looked after foster children for about seven years and at one time I had looked after thirteen stray dogs. The neighbours' children used to come with me to take the dogs for walks.

Then I went to fetch a plate of mince pies for them. I put six on a plate and said, "Help yourselves." They lifted a mince pie each as though their hands were magnetic.

I saw that they were looking at the packets of cigarettes. I said, "Those are cigarettes. I'll show you how people smoke them." I struck a match and lit a cigarette. They leapt back as though they were frightened. At the same time I heard another 'bleep' sound which seemed to come from the back garden.

They began to float towards the back door. They were still holding a mince pie each. I stubbed out the cigarette and ran after them calling out, "Come back! Come back! Please come back!"

Suddenly I saw an orange glowing thing on the back garden. It must have been a spaceship. It looked about eight feet long by four feet high and it had glowing round windows or port-holes in it. I couldn't see through the port-holes. The spaceship was covered with a sort of shining plastic. There was something like a 'scorpion tail' at the back with a kind of wheel on the top of it, like a wheel without a rim, flashing a blue light when it rose up.

They went towards the spaceship. The next thing I saw was this glowing spaceship flashing the lights twice as though to say "Goodbye". It rose straight up over the fence and away towards Oldbury. The sky was still dark and there was snow on the ground.

Hobo came to life then and wandered about the garden as though he was looking for them. I thought, "They didn't even say 'Thank you' for the mince pies." I wish I hadn't lit that cigarette. They must be afraid of fire.

I was sorry that they had gone but I felt warm and happy and 'good' as though I had been blessed.

When I went back into the house I realised that the clock had stopped and the radio also. I talked to my next door neighbour and she suggested ringing the police. I rang the Oldbury police and they said they would come. I rang my husband but he couldn't leave his job. I said to him, "I have had visitors with wings." I was shaking and crying. He said, "What d'you mean? Birds?" I said, "No. Little men with wings." He laughed and said, "Why don't you go and get your hair done and tell the girls about it?" I did that later and they were very kind, but they must have felt it was a strange story.

The police came from West Bromwich police station. They said, "You look pale as though you have had a shock." Then they said, "Aren't you cold with all the doors open?" Although it was such a cold morning I felt warm and happy. The police couldn't do much. I couldn't expect them to take finger prints!

They went away and came back again later. They rang a Group in Birmingham, UFO Studies Investigation Service. Some members of the Group came and took measurements of the mark in the garden that was left when the spaceship took off. It was an oblong mark about eight feet long by four feet wide. We have seen photographs that were taken at the time - clear marks in the snow. People checked with electronic equipment but we haven't heard the results yet. They also took soil samples for analysis but as the ground was frozen hard they didn't expect good results. We were told that there was more sodium than normal, but I don't know much about these things.

There is a circle scratched on the glass of the back door, on the glass panels, as though it was cut with a diamond. Someone suggested that the dog

might have done it, but he couldn't reach and anyway a dog couldn't scratch a circle on glass I should think. The mark on the glass wasn't there before January 4th.

I have had a lot of nice letters from people who were interested in the story after reading about it in the newspapers. Some people sent tapes for me to record my story.

I was asked to speak on BBC TV's "Nationwide", but the weather was very bad and the driver of the hired car who took us, my husband and myself, from Rowley Regis, took the wrong road and we finished up at Derby instead of Nottingham and couldn't get to the studio in time for the interview.

The West Bromwich College of Technology (Television Production course students) made a film of me talking to one of the students about my experience. It was shown at the College studio on March 19th 1979. (Something has gone wrong with the film now. We were told that it 'shakes and wobbles.')

My eyes were sore for about a week after the beings came. I had to wear dark glasses. I had to have a few weeks off work as I didn't feel well and the doctor advised me to have a rest. My jaws ached for days afterwards because of standing, staring, open-mouthed with shock, when the beings first came.

I have never read books about UFOs. I don't read much except the newspapers. I like "Crossroads" on television and "Coronation Street", and perhaps a love story sometimes.

Some people have made jokes about me and there have been jokes in the newspapers, but people who know me believe me as they know I am truthful.

The beings looked like puppets to me at first but there were no strings! The newspapers called them Martians. I noticed that the beings didn't seem to have knees as we do. They had stiff legs that hung straight down when they floated and when they sat on the couch their legs stuck straight out. Some people wrote to say that they thought the 'visitors' might have been elves or beings from the Faerie Kingdom. I don't know what to call them. I don't know what to think. I know I shall never forget them if I live to be a hundred.

I have a red patch on my brow that seems to get worse sometimes when I have a headache. I think it was caused by the bright light round the heads of the beings.

A few days later we tried the tapes that had been handled by the beings. They were so distorted that they were ruined. They were perfectly alright before that morning.

A few weeks later a woman I work with said, "Oh, what's happened to your wedding ring. It has gone white." I hadn't noticed it myself but the gold wedding ring is now dead white, (silver outside, gold inside). I don't know what could have caused it."

Notes

- 1) The silver 'foil streamers hanging down the beings' fronts were thought to be responsible for the "zee" sounds when they entered the house.
- 2) The beings' voices sounded gruff and those of men, and they spoke in ordinary English.
- 3) Mrs. Hingley thought of the beings as being adults, but their behaviour was child-like. In one instance, the beings slapped their chests when Mrs. Hingley spoke of children as if to show their pleasure, or as if to say, "We are children". The episode on the couch is another example.
- 4) Since it was still dark when the beings departed, it would appear that they had stayed something less than one hour.
- 5) Mrs. Hingley still has to wear dark glasses when the Sun is shining brightly, but the red mark on her brow has now virtually disappeared. Although the grass is growing in the small rear garden, the deep grooves left by the spaceship are still very prominent (June '79).
- 6) Since the encounter, Mrs. Hingley feels that she wants to talk to people about the experience and about Jesus for she feels that she was chosen to tell people about the Bible. She also makes reference to Jesus as the meaning of the Christmas tree, and now even wants to give up her job in order to help people. Mrs. Hingley is a very kind person although she has some contempt for other religions and other nationalities, but Mrs. Morris feels that these are not qualities due to the encounter, but perhaps the result of her upbringing.

Mrs. Morris also feels that hypnotism would help to recall the encounter more accurately as Mrs. Hingley does appear to get a little confused over certain aspects of the case.

(The above notes were extracted from correspondence with Mrs. Hingley following interviews with the witness over a five month period.)

AN UNUSUAL CONTACTEE* : A case including the psychic aspect.

*For those not familiar with the term, "Contactee" simply means someone who is believed to have been contacted in some way by an intelligence believed to be connected with the UFO phenomenon.

Introduction - As far as we here at EARTHLINK are concerned, this is one of the most unusual cases we have personally come across, and, because of the amount of information that we wish to present, have decided to spread the story over two, or even three, issues.

As in many other contactee cases, the person involved here claims to have experienced unusual happenings from an early age, but although you may feel from reading just this first part that the case is typical of the 'ordinary' contactee (if one can class the average contactee as such), there have been recent indications that our witness has been chosen for some task - as yet completely unknown - of great importance.

The witness of the following events who, for the sake of his anonymity, we shall call "Bob", has been in touch with us for two years now, and we have been following his story with great excitement and curiosity.

The Early Years

Although Bob is not absolutely positive, these weird happenings began when he was about seven years old - around 1956/57. At that time, Bob lived in Chingford, Essex, and found, from what he can remember now, 20 years later, that he was having some very unusual dreams and receiving pictures in his mind of spacecraft of one sort or another - in addition to receiving in "some way" messages. One craft that Bob received a picture in his mind of he also saw while in his garden and it was accompanied by the sound of "Vulcan bombers": this same craft was to play an important part in his experiences many years later. One important (?) message he says he received while only 7 or 8 year's old was that when he reached about 40 year's of age he was going to leave this planet "and be taken to the north-west planet system, which is west, in the middle of July 16." (As a matter of interest, this takes us up to about 1990.)

Bob, 29, is a straightforward, average sort of person, is not religious, is of average intelligence and isn't very different from anyone else - except that he claims to possess an incredible ability to project some part of his mind out of his physical body to anywhere he chooses and see what his detached mind's eye views - even out of the Earth's atmosphere. This sort of "mind control", Bob says, is very exhausting, and he says he has been able to do this for years.

Latter Day Events

Moving nearer now to the present day; for the last seven years Bob has lived in Saffron Walden with his parents, Saffron Walden lying in north-west Essex near the Cambridge/Suffolk borders, and it was to be here that the UFOs and other strange related phenomena were to really make themselves felt to him. Bob's first sighting, though, was to take place nearer his old home not far from Chingford.

One day in the spring of 1976 - probably March - Bob was playing golf at a place called High Beach, which lies in Epping Forest - to the north-east of London. At around 4.00 p.m. he noticed a pair of flashing square lights high up in the clear blue sky, and these lights appeared to be descending. The object displaying the lights was thought to be quite large and was shaped like an ice-cream wafer with domes on top and a bulge underneath (see fig. 1). This object was bluish in colour and hovered at an altitude of one mile perhaps.

For maybe five minutes the lights flashed on and off like stroboscopes and between each flash there was a dimmer beam of horizontal light. After this the object reversed its course and diminished to just a dot in the sky. Shortly after came a whole series of sightings and weird events, but the order they're listed in here is only approximate following the next few sightings for there was too much going on for Bob's memory to place in a neat, chronological order.

One spring day during the same period, around March/April 1976, Bob witnessed a silvery-pink object in the sky over Saffron Walden at about 3.30 p.m., but as it drew nearer he could see that it had the shape of two colossal breeze blocks joined end to end and recalled a dream he had had a long, long time before of this same craft and the colours even matched as well! The object appeared to be some sort of hovercraft with a dark casing on the underside and steel framed windows on top (see fig.2). Following immediately behind was an orange coloured smoke trail, which, Bob thought, may have been given this colour by the bright sunshine.

The craft then came to a halt perhaps no more than one mile away, and it was here that the object's colossal size could be judged. Bob guessed that it was in the order of one-third of a mile or more long. Then came the unexpected - an explosion with pinkish smoke in the middle section. Moving off at a fair speed in a westerly direction went the first half of the object quickly followed by the second half with a roar and a gush of orange smoke. But this was not all, for the two sections returned from the west, went to the east, and then returned once more whereupon the first half came to a halt while the second half linked up with it to become one again. When the two finally moved off to the west there was a faint noise like distant thunder followed by a large cloud of orange smoke seemingly coming from the lower half of the rear section. They then disappeared behind a cloud in the distance and were seen no more.

Although there were other people around in the street where Bob saw this object, no-one else appeared to see it, and for some reason which Bob doesn't know the answer to he never pointed it out to anyone or said anything.

Some days later Bob was in town again when upon looking up he saw two wide, parallel expanses of billowing black smoke, but no craft to speak of. Whatever craft made the smoke trails, though, Bob was sure was far larger than anything made by man.

Then, on the evening of the same day, Bob saw two strip lights in the sky from his rear garden, which were very bright and pulsating - one red, one blue. Both were long and narrow and just hung in the sky for five minutes or so before disappearing, the lights fading from the bottom up. However, Bob felt there was something else in the sky for every few minutes there was the sound of engines starting up and a down-draught of "hot, smelly air, something like rubber and gasoline."




Fig.3. The being made up of strip lights. Each light was transparent & with rounded ends. Being was in view 30 secs. perhaps.

Then, as Bob was standing in the garden, a human-shaped form of some 6ft.(1.83m.) tall materialised in front of him and this was in the form of strips of light, horizontal and one on top of the other (see fig.3). Although startled, Bob put his hand through it but felt nothing, and the image just faded away. This was just the beginning of what was to be a memorable night.

Bob's feelings were mixed throughout all these weird happenings and he experienced excitement, wonder, fear and happiness all rolled into one! His only regret was that he couldn't get anyone to back up his sightings: he was always the only one to experience all these events and this is reflected in his writings where he constantly ponders the possibility that it is all just imagination - so incredible are the things he says he has experienced.

Bob returned from the garden and went to his bedroom where he switched on his (car) tape player, which was working off a transformer. The English voices on the tape, though, suddenly changed to an unknown language and there was interference present.

If all the foregoing wasn't enough, then what was Bob to make of the following?




Fig.1. The UFO seen at High Beach which exhibited stroboscopic-like lights.




Fig.2. The "breeze-blocks" UFO. "Black underneath, silvery-pink on top with glass at the front & side." Total length - One third of a mile (0.54Km.) approx.




Fig.4. Some of the luminous objects that fell through Bob's bedroom ceiling. Colours: Silvery-white and bluish in the middle.

Appearing through the ceiling and coming through the window were myriads of odd and even-shaped lights: everywhere Bob went in the house the lights appeared (see fig.4) and hovered, turned inside out and generally hit objects. One incredible light object Bob saw could only be described as a Flying Bedstead.

Then, when halfway down the stairs, Bob saw "a human being 'beamed' into the passageway below." He then heard the roar of a high wind and at the same time the being moved extremely rapidly out of sight through the kitchen door, and Bob was only able to catch the back side of this 'person' who he described as having long brown hair, a blue shirt, brown trousers and no shoes!

Looking out of the window, Bob heard the sound of engines and there was a hot smell in the air.

Just before going to bed, Bob had the strange feeling that the bedroom was in some way "magnetised." The events of that evening were just too incredible to believe, but this was only the early days!

That night, Bob felt one side of his bed sink down - pillow as well - as though someone else was in bed with him, someone who couldn't be made to move for there was no physical person there, although Bob could feel a form of heat on one side of his face as though it came from this invisible person.

Then, incredibly, the face of the alarm clock appeared to move outwards and turn through 90° as though the clock's face was in motion. It had the appearance of bright orange, hands and numbers also. Shortly after it faded away.

When the weight on the bed had gone, through the open window came a bluish coloured gas which was made up of "small cells." This gas, which was in the arrangement of four horizontal beams of light, made its way over Bob's bed but Bob decided to stay where he was (in bed) and see what happened. The light beams then came down and somehow filtered through him with considerable force for Bob felt he was under a great load. The rest of that night was a very uneasy one for Bob.

The next UFO sighting was to be perhaps the most significant of all, but we'll leave this and other incredible events until the next issue.

UFO NEWS & EVENTS AROUND THE WORLD

Johan (10) saw two men in the air

At Schoonaarde-Dendermonde (Province of East Flanders, Belgium) there was not only snow in the air these last days. Johan Van Boven (10 year's old) of Steenweg, near Wetteren 133/A, saw something else. Something very strange: a large flying saucer with two small domes on top and a little ladder underneath. There was something still much stranger: two striped men of iron (1) who (just framed in Johan's bedroom window) were climbing up the little ladder to get in and then to disappear in the grey morning mist with their flying saucer in the direction of Wetteren. It was Monday, 1st January, between 8 and 9 o'clock (a.m.)

Eight year's ago - "Johan was wide awake when he saw it, for I heard him playing loudly on his bed, together with his friend Dimitri who was staying here", recounted his mother, Rachel Van Boyen-DeGeest. Did Dimitri see it also? "Yes, but only just. When Johan called out, 'Look there, Dimitri,' the boy ducked under the blankets with fear. But there is more to indicate that Johan was not lying and is not making it up. Eight year's ago I saw the same thing here in the sky behind the house. But I must admit, without men. Also the large, greyish shining disk was flying in the other direction, from Wetteren to Dendermonde. It was night then, between 3 and 4 o'clock. I was up because Johan was ill. I never wanted to tell anybody. I said: No, people laugh at such things. But now Johan, too....." Didn't Johan call his mother, who was at home on this New Year's morning? "No, he tried to photograph it all with his polaroid camera. But there wasn't any film on it. A great pity. From now on he is given every evening when he goes to bed a camera that is loaded. The UFO must not go into the mist again."

Strange noises and horoscope - Did Johan say right away how the New Year began for him? His mother, Rachel: "He kept it three days to himself and his little friend Dimitri, who left for home on January 2nd, and did not dare speak of it either. But Wednesday evening Johan was sitting next to me in the easy chair. 'Mummy,' he said, 'I am going to tell you something. You will not believe me. Yet it is true.' Then came his story about the saucer with the domes and the little ladder - a strange mushroom that came gliding from behind a cloud and surrounded by several smaller round disks. About the two men stepping into space (T.N. not striding in space) but clearly visible, for they were not very far.

Here in the air, close to our garden. Their robot-shaped armour, that seemed to be of iron, was striped horizontally, but they moved supply in it. As soon as they got inside, the craft shot immediately away, so that there were probably others on board. The spectacle, according to Johan, lasted a very short time, a minute at the most."

On Thursday, Johan appeared too shy to recount his story himself. His mother excused him; "He is not one hundred per cent a boy like any other. At school he is noticeably backward, especially in what concerns reading and writing, but, apart from that, he is very clever."

His father, Petrus Van Boven in his turn: "You can rest assured, the boy is not going to lie. To be sure, all the things that happen in the sky these days! Who can still remain undisturbed by it all. Do you know that we perceive here at night more suspicious noises, knocking and humming. That all the dogs in the neighbourhood sometimes begin barking altogether and yet there is nothing suspicious to be seen."

Rachel Van Boven: "After Johan's story on Wednesday evening, I immediately looked at his horoscope for New Year Week. He is the Fishes and look at what is written for him: 'You will experience an adventure and you will be attracted to activities which will reach a wide circle.' Rather remarkable, isn't it? Not that I blindly believe in these things, but still had I followed last week the horoscope tip of the Sunday News, then I would have had a 5 on the lottery. Now I have only 4."

The Fire Brigade of Wetteren also saw the luminous disk

A strange craft in the sky, a flying saucer? Or a UFO if this sounds better? The inclination to laugh remains irresistible with most. Yet the story told by the 10-year-old boy and his mother who both live at Schoonaarde-Dendermonde was not rejected by some as a joke.

There are, for instance, an architect, Lieut. Van Alboom, and his four team members of the voluntary fire brigade of Wetteren. "On January 2nd, a busy day of battling against the winter elements, we were called out in the evening to Kalken to take off a broken antenna from the roof of the house of the Van de Velde family in the Vaarstraat. It was about 21.20 hours. Suddenly we saw a turning luminous disk in the sky above Kalkse Vaart-Schellebelle Aard, moving swiftly in the direction of Schoonaarde. A plane? No, it was certainly not a plane. What then? Something strange. But it was flying there. Really and truly."

"I believe it" - We took note gravely. But we cannot do otherwise than declare that the fire brigade of Wetteren perceived a disk (another spoke of a ball, a fireball) about two kilometres away from Schoonaarde-Dendermonde. And this is the place where Johan Van Boven saw looming "a large saucer with domes and a crew", circling out of the morning mist.

One of the five men from Wetteren, who "only knows about it with certainty that it was not a plane, not a lunar disk, nor the star of the three kings" (T.N. children go from door to door with a star-shaped wand at this time of the year), is André Aerssens, still deeply impressed on Friday. "Yes, I also saw it. A strange experience. We all of us looked at it in amazement. It flew quite rapidly, but didn't make any noise. We would not have thought much of it, but now that the story from Schoonaarde was in the paper, it naturally cropped up again."

The other members of the fire brigade are Willy Raes, André Claus and August Seys. We had the undertaker, Willy Raes, living in the Kerkstraat in Wetteren, also on the line Thursday. "No. I cannot say that I saw it myself. I was sitting on the roof in the snow and needed all my faculties to keep up there. But I heard the hubbub amongst my mates below and they also told me about it afterwards. I believe firmly in it."

Silver light in Ukkel (T.N. suburb of Bruxelles)

There came a response from Ukkel over our report on the sightings in Schoonaarde - Dendermonde. A reader informed us that she was walking along the Mesidorlaan in Ukkel shortly after 9 a.m. in October when she observed a shining silver ball which travelled rapidly towards Wetteren.

Also a UFO trail in the Ghent region

It is not only in the Dendermonde and Wetteren region that something like a UFO or flying saucer was seen these last days, but also in the region of Ghent. "Very clearly, but very queer and completely noiseless. According to Sabena, certainly not a plane"

The man who came to recount this to us on Saturday (after the accounts of the boy from Schoonaarde and the fire brigade from Wetteren) does not wish to have his name in the paper. He is afraid of derision from those who "have not yet seen anything like that and therefore will laugh, as I used to." His story:

"It was Friday evening the 5th January, around 7.30 p.m. I was standing with my car at the Seca petrol station at Ertvelde-Kluizen, and there it was, flying. Or rather, I could only see it in the dark sky as the lights of a strange, large craft. In a square: four strong searchlights, within that also four smaller orange coloured lights and finally, in the centre, a flashing light. It glided noiselessly, though not very rapidly. The pump attendant and I were able to follow it (T.N. with the eyes) till it disappeared in the distance."

Our Ghent observer remained puzzled about it until Saturday morning. "Could it have been a plane after all?" He rang up the Sabena airport. "Yes, I did want to know. They assured me that a plane with orange lights does not exist."

Again in October - After the reader from Ukkel who previously mentioned that she had observed a "shiny silver ball" in October, there is also a builder, Daniel Uyttendae Kwatvechtstraat 59, in Wetteren.

"You may print my name. I am used to being ridiculed since I saw this fireball in October and spoke about it at work. They would end by calling someone a little Martian. But what I saw, I saw. That October evening at about a quarter to seven, I was driving home when I caught sight of the thing a couple of hundred metres from my house. How strange, a flying fireball, thought I. Once home, I could still see, from my front garden, the ball clearly but noiselessly gliding in the direction of Bruxelles. My wife, whom I called out, also caught a glimpse of it. From that moment, I was sure of it: this is a flying saucer, and I remain by that assertion. Besides, for some time I have had the impression that we are more or less constantly watched, threatened from above."

The specialists and the child - Meantime, UFO preoccupations are increasing daily in the Van Boven-GeGeest family in Schoonaarde-Dendermonde, where their 10-year-old son Johan saw from his bedroom window on the morning of New Year's Day "the saucer object with the two striped men of iron", appear out of the snowy skies.

His mother, Rachel, Saturday evening: "The specialists also know now where we live. Letters have arrived with forms to fill in from UFO Organisations and we have just had a visit from three ufologists from Bruges. What Johan saw is extremely interesting, they said. The saucer with the domes and the little ladder is not of so much interest, for we've known for a long time with certainty that such things exist and fly, said the gentlemen, but it is the men who, in their striped armour, came through the fog to get into shining white craft by the little ladder. According to the ufologists, our Johan is the fourth Belgian, and of these the first child to mention that type of crew. They are apparently fellows 1.90m. to 2m. tall, and even taller. They always wear a fairly heavy hip belt, to the clasp of which a small rectangular case is attached. Johan had also noticed this belt. And from at least a hundred different figures that were submitted to Johan on drawing paper by the UFO specialists, Johan chose the same one as his predecessors of Mechelen, Antwerp and other places in the country. The right one, estimated the gentlemen, who will also forward our case to still more knowledgeable UFO specialists abroad." But let us not forget, with all this, to look up into the sky.

Tiny Grenada, its crusade to get the UN interested in UFOs ignored for three years, yesterday called for a study of the phenomena to help the cause of world peace. Since 1975 the United Nations has rebuffed all of Gairy's attempts to establish an agency concentrating on UFOs. Yesterday he lowered his sights and asked only that a special three-member group of UFO experts be added to the staff of the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space.

Authorities said one of the unidentified flying objects hovered about 30 feet over the patrol car of policeman Francisco Diaz Cortes and emitted a red light that turned on the car's siren and made it spin around.

The policeman said the UFO then descended rapidly behind some nearby hills and when he gave chase he found another flying object.

The police said they fired on the UFOs, both of which took off after rapidly emitting red light.

What Killed Brothers in Triangle of Terror?

Things are quiet now...but Italian fishermen in the Adriatic between the ports of San Benedetto and Pescara live in daily dread of another "visitation". Giant water spouts, vivid orange balls of fire, mysterious metallic objects flying through space and an eerie, out-of-this-world atmosphere made up the first "visitation" which the fishermen claim overwhelmed them in a triangle of the Adriatic last year. They call it a "visitation" because there has been no scientific explanation.

It all began in October, 1978.--When the two Fulgentiis brothers failed to return from a fishing trip, other boats went to look for them. Divers found their boat, undamaged, near the spot at which it had last been sighted. Nearby, on the sea bed, they found the bodies of the brothers. There were inexplicable puncture marks on their faces. And the absence of water in their lungs was evidence they had not drowned. They died of shock, say other fishermen--at something they had seen, or experienced, before they went down with their boat.

Two other fishermen described what they experienced a month later. Suddenly, some strange force began to push their boat sideways. "It paralysed us with fright. We were being moved sideways at nine or 10 miles an hour for about 15 minutes. It was irresistible and we had no control of the boat. But the sea was calm - as smooth as a mirror."

Daily reports began to come in of incidents which turned that stretch of the Adriatic into a Terror Triangle.

The Riccis, father and son, say they were sailing in a calm sea when a column of water roughly 20ft. round at the base shot about 500ft. into the air "with tremendous force." Mario Mara reported: "A huge orange light hovered over our boat five miles offshore. It blinded us for five or six seconds, then disappeared."

Flaviano Mattiucci said: "A huge orange light moved like a disc on the sea near my boat. Its speed was incredible."

Antonio Palleca saw an orange light in the sky. "Then I spotted a metallic object twice the size of my boat. I almost went mad with fright and headed for the coast, not daring to look over my shoulder."

A naval patrol boat was sent in to investigate reports.

Suddenly the captain was confronted by one red light at sea level. The light shot up to 1,000ft. and then disappeared. He searched the area and found nothing. When he returned to the spot at which he had seen the strange light, both his radio and his radar ceased to function.

Some experts dismissed the reports as just another case of "flying saucer fever". Many Italians believe the triangle is the site used by NATO for weapon testing. Others think the sightings were due to "unknown atmospheric phenomena causing unusual luminosity."

But San Benedetto municipal official Dr. Alberto Perozzi isn't so sure. He says: "Nothing has been satisfactorily explained to us. The people along the coast are mature and sensible."

A young man who has extra-terrestrial contacts

Juan Juanotena, a young ufologist of Pamplona (Spain), is assured that he has contact with extra-terrestrial beings. He says that from April he has been in contact with beings from other planets.

In an interview published yesterday in the newspaper "Diario de Navarra" he says that when an accident with a container lorry happened on 10th August in Villaba, the trailer overturned and fell on several houses - but he had foreseen the accident half a minute before. He "also knew beforehand that the container was empty and that no-one would be hurt. I made my way to the scene of the accident where several people had already surrounded the overturned lorry including the civil police. I then foretold the arrival of a UFO and so it happened as all the people there were able to see. After the first one (UFO) I also predicted the arrival of another, and I also knew the direction in which it would appear. This second time I was also proven right."

Cattle Mutilation Mystery Unsolved

Are UFO occupants mutilating cattle to monitor our planet for nuclear build-up? No one knows for sure, but this theory is gaining much underground popularity.

In late 1976 or early 1977 two dead and mutilated cows were found just east of the Rocky Flats nuclear weapons plant. Jefferson County Sheriff's Officers can't remember the exact date and their report on the incident has somehow disappeared from the files. But J.T. Warren, head of investigations, said it was "when the mutilation scare was going on all over the country and most especially in eastern Colorado."

In early 1976 mutilations were occurring in such large numbers that Gov. Dick Lamm, under pressure from cattle ranchers, had asked the Colorado Bureau of Investigation to intervene and find the cause. Though they were called mutilations, the term is not exactly accurate. Cattle were cut up in very specific ways, always with only certain organs or parts of organs missing.

"Since the FBI was involved, within two hours the cows were immediately shipped to Colorado State University." Warren said of the Rocky Flats cases. CSU served as Colorado's laboratory center to determine the cause of the deaths.

After testing, CSU scientists finally attributed the deaths to natural causes and the mutilations to other animals. The CBI closed its investigation in 1977, claiming they could no longer commit resources to it.

However, speculation has not ended. "There are as many theories as there were missing cows," said Carl Whiteside, CBI's chief investigator. "You cannot imagine the lengths we went to to determine whether this was a real problem and we decided it was not." Still, questions remain.

Although no more mutilated cattle have been found near Rocky Flats since the first two, researcher David Perkins of southern Colorado says the mutilations continue to occur across the state.

According to Warren, the dead cattle at Rocky Flats showed what now appear to be the classic signs of mutilation seen from Minnesota to Texas and back up to Washington.

Missing are the sexual organs, udders and intestines, an eye and specific other soft tissue areas. These tissue areas, Perkins says, are most significant for testing nuclear build-up in animal and plant life.

The way organs were removed left the cow cored clean, as if cut by a sharp cookie cutter rather than a knife or some animal chewing it out. Perkins says the removal could only be done by someone with sophisticated technology, not animals chewing.

The most common theories are that mutilations are the work of satanic cults, that they are a secret government project - as dead cattle are usually found downstream or downwind from nuclear installations - or that UFOs, monitoring the planet for nuclear buildup, are using the cattle as test animals.

This last theory is obviously the one that's aroused the most interest.

Asked what he thought of the UFO theory, Warren said, "I don't know. I'm not going to say it could be UFOs and I can't say it definitely isn't."

Update - "There are some strange things that have happened that haven't been explained to me completely." The strangeness of this spate of mutilations reportedly included facts like: at the time of their occurrence, there are increased reports of UFOs in the area; that cattle are left without any blood and there is no blood on the ground.

Burn marks are noticed on the ground; bones are broken inside the carcass, making it appear that it was dropped from some height; the incisions are extremely precise; clamp marks are noticed on the hind quarters as if the cow had been lifted in the air; sometimes tripod marks are noticed nearby in the snow - as if a craft had landed; and nobody in the area ever reports hearing any noise, as would be noticeable if a helicopter had been around.

Though the mutilations are indeed strange - the UFO theorists may be getting carried away. Recent reports of cattle mutilations in Nederland, showing these classic signs, have not turned up anything strange, or at least no one is willing to come out and say for sure.

In late summer two mutilated cows were discovered on property of the Paul Bunyan Lumber Company. Although some Nederland residents say there was a rash of UFO sightings around that time, that tripod marks were noticed on the ground, and that there were "strange noises in the woods," Town Marshall Jim Carson says nothing was reported.

Sam Witt, who saw the cows, at first thought they looked strange, then read about the mutilations and thought perhaps that was it. "I found out later, though, there were some calves that died and a neighbour had made traps out of them to catch coyotes."

UFO researchers say people who see them will often not admit it or make a formal report as they fear being branded as weird, which might explain the lack of reports at Carson.

But coyote traps do not explain the hundreds of cattle missing specific things like the tip of one ear, one eye, part of the tongue and the sexual organs.

But at this point, the CBI is not going any further on investigations, no additional mutilations have been reported in Boulder County, but Perkins says they are still continuing throughout the rest of the state.

"Who knows how many there are," Whiteside says.

A Venezuelan reporter says he receives telepathic teachings from extraterrestrials. Great changes are about to occur and they want to help us.

Caracas (EFE) - A Venezuelan reporter claims having received teachings by extraterrestrials "telepathically and through other means". Ex-reporter Isidro Casanova told EFE that in the last months he received instructions about quantum mechanics, energy transformation, psychology and several other subjects, from beings "of a higher level, who communicate with me telepathically and through persons who act as intermediaries". Casanova, who for years was a reporter of "El Informador", a paper of Barquisimeto (Western Venezuela), stated he is presently preparing a book with his experiences and the teachings he received, indicating at the same time he intends to hold a course about extraterrestrials". Casanova assured at the same time that a UFO base has been established in the mountains of Terepaima, near Barquisimeto, and cited as proof statements from local residents and his own observations, in the sense that at night numerous oval flying objects appear there, which emit multicoloured light flashes. "Besides, there are traces left nearby by one of the UFOs - he recalled - some time ago. A large crater was observed, with calcined earth around it, and tests have determined that the temperature that caused calcination could not have been produced by any of the means we have available on our planet". According to Casanova, the extraterrestrials are very interested in the things that happen on Earth, "because great changes are about to occur on our planet, and they want to help us be prepared so they cause the least possible damage". Casanova gave to understand that these modifications would relate to intense activity of the earth's crust, as well as climatic and geological changes, "which has always happened when one era ends and another begins, as now, when we are entering the era of Aquarius". The ex-Venezuelan reporter considers that extraterrestrials "are already among us... They adopt different shapes and assume different personalities on Earth to perform their tasks of assistance to avoid our being really 'shocked' by not being prepared for their revelations". The UFO student also stated that there is in the Mato Grosso mountains (Brazil) the first big UFO base established by extraterrestrials, and claimed that a "clinic" operates in Mexico, where they perform amazing operations through their advanced knowledge of medicine. Finally, Casanova, who mentioned Jesus Christ as one of the extraterrestrials who have visited us in the past, declined to reveal the earthly identity of his informers from outer space, at the same time not explaining by which means they choose their human disciples.

'Man made UFOs in our skies' Scientist's amazing claim.

Many "UFOs" are actually man made machines using a new form of energy, an anti-gravity device, claims an American physicist. These saucer-like machines are being kept a secret by the US Government and an aerospace company until the fuel shortage becomes critical, he says.

A possible centre for experiments in what is called electro-gravatic propulsion is Pine Gap near Alice Springs (Australia).

These claims are made by Perth-based Mr. Stan Deyo in his book *The Cosmic Conspiracy*. The book, published in Perth by his own company, West Australian Texas Trading, has sold 17,000 copies in Australia since January.

Mr. Deyo liberally documents evidence of the anti-gravity device which he says he was involved in as a young scientist for a 49-company conglomerate in Dallas, Texas.

He is continuing his own research into anti-gravity energy in Perth, and claims this "flying saucer" technology has now been perfected but the knowledge suppressed.

In his book he offers documents, scientific papers, reports from journals, and statements from scientists as proof that "electric flying machines" using anti-gravity devices are a reality and have been the subject of a gigantic conspiracy of silence.

Among his many quotes is one from the vice-president of advanced design of the Glenn L. Martin Aircraft Co: "Unlimited power, freedom from gravitational attraction, and infinitely short travel time are now becoming feasible."

Another source is Edward Lear, aircraft manufacturer, who in 1956 said: "I feel flying saucers are real because there are now serious efforts in progress to prove the existence of anti-gravitational forces."

American author Intel, in Washington, 1956: "Electro gravitics research seeking the source of gravity and its control has reached a stage where profound implications for the entire human race begin to emerge."

Mr. Deyo says electric flying saucers are a real phenomenon and are intelligently controlled.

Some are modern, some are ancient

Some are man-made and some are not; some are modern and some are ancient.

"Many government agencies have covered up major findings concerning the UFO situation," he says.

"Some multi-national corporations have researched and developed the advanced technological process. They have ultimately produced electrically-propelled circular-winged aircraft, submarines and spacecraft." He lists a number of incidents in the world that could have a connection with these new flights.

One involves the disappearance of Frederick Valentich in October last year on a flight between Melbourne and King Island. "One must consider the possibility that Valentich had seen too much of the top secret RAAF-UFO records at Sale Airforce base," he says. "Valentich had become a security problem to those in the know. He could have been grabbed on purpose."

Other connecting incidents are given including a Chilean army corporal making contact with a UFO in 1977, electrified cattle of 1975, a jet v UFO interception in Iran in 1976, and a missing photograph of a UFO by astronauts McDivitt and Cooper in 1976.

Mr. Deyo says the US joint defence and space research facility at Pine Gap could have been a centre for research into electromagnetic propulsion since 1966.

Some people claimed white discs about 10 metres in diameter with US Air Force markings had been ferried into Australia.

They had been landed at one or the other of the two airports serving Pine Gap.

Mr. Deyo, a controversial figure in scientific circles, also writes about project Noah's Ark, a system of 96 bunkers and "bolt holes" established in the US to house about 6,500 key officials in case of a nuclear war.

He deals with a number of groups connected with mysticism, research, security, and power which play key roles in what he calls a "conspiracy in the affairs of man."

Will it be possible to solve the mysterious object found in Dalbuszki?

As investigations are still continuing, the origin of an extraordinary object the shape of a plate 50cm. diameter and 30kg. weight has yet to be determined. The object was found in the village of Dalbuszki near the town of Gostynia (Poland).

The Director of the Astronomical Observatory at the University of Adam Mickiewicza in Poznaniu, Prof. Hieronim Hurnik, examined the object where it was found and gave his verdict that it wasn't a meteorite and neither was it a fragment from any satellites which may have been destroyed in the upper layers of the atmosphere. The scientist then gave the information to a newspaper reporter for the "Kurier", and a sample of the object was sent to a laboratory at the Museum for Archaeology & Minerology in Lodzi.

The vice-director of the museum and head of the laboratory, Andrzej Kanwiszer, gave his opinion after examining the sample. Some people had thought that the object was part of a container - in use up to the 18th century - that was used to melt various metal ores, but the vice-director didn't believe this was the case. Most intriguing was the finding of the lab's spectograph, which revealed the presence of nickel, the characteristic metal found in meteorites, along with other materials such as cobalt, copper, molybdenum, vanadium and lead.

A detailed report of the lab's findings with the spectograph was then sent to a specialist at the Institute for Material analysis and Polytechnic for Metal Technology at Lodzkiej.

We have heard that they will conduct a most scrupulous investigation, but it is possible that in order to give a final verdict as to where the peculiar object originally came from it will be necessary to inspect the whole "saucer", which they presently have at the Astronomical Observatory in Poznaniu.

Strange Outer Space Force Manipulates Our Satellites

Something very odd is happening to our satellites and extraterrestrial forces may be responsible by tampering with our outer space hardware.

One of the more interesting side effects that the United States race into space has produced is the immense amount of junk that has been shot into orbit.

Tens of thousands of tons of satellites and multi-staged vehicle parts circle the Earth every minute. A good number of the satellites have long been dead due to battery failure, decaying orbits and faulty instrument arrays.

Aside from the vast amount of metal that we have shot into orbit, there are the space programs of the Soviet Union, China, France, Japan, and other technological innovators throughout the world to consider.

Another one of the more interesting and obscure side effects comes to light with some well documented cases of the past two decades.

In October of 1962, Anna, the "firefly" satellite, was launched into orbit. Its original purpose was to provide a more accurate means of measuring the Earth. Towards the end of December, Anna blacked out. No signals could be sent or received from her. Then, seven months later, technicians began receiving signals again.

No explanation was ventured as to its demise or equally sudden resurrection. Technicians were just grateful to see that their costly project had not been a complete waste.

Then in May of 1963, Telstar II was launched into space and suddenly and unaccountably, died two months later. It stopped sending signals of any kind, and one scientist attributed its untimely failure to a meteor. Three-and-a-half weeks later, it resumed its operations just as abruptly and mysteriously as it ceased them. Once again, technicians were startled but grateful.

Approximately a year ago, Atlanta papers quoted Wayne Meshjian, a physics professor at Longwood College in Farmville, Virginia, as contending that something was interfering with the telemetry of two NOAA (National Oceanographic and Atmosphere Administration) satellites over the area commonly known as the Bermuda Triangle.

Meshjian reported that the satellites photograph an area twice. The first picture transmitted a clear normal shot while the second picture was an infrared shot.

This is normal procedure. However, whenever the satellites are over the Bermuda Triangle, the second picture was invariably wiped off the receiver. It is interesting to note the second shot, the infrared one, revealed sources of heat under the ocean that are impossible to detect by conventional means.

Until more is known, speculation is tempting and interesting.


