ROCHDALE UFO REPORT (PART 1).

In order to help solve a Mystery that has come upon us quite unsuspectingly, the following reports are being held over, but will appear in a later issue.

1. Report of three bright lights near Castleton.
2. Almost at the same time a UFO was seen over Oldham Edge.
3. A Mr. Hill and his wife living in flats in central Rochdale saw a glowing object at 10.05 p.m.

At this point you have just read the introduction to the UFO sightings reported and put into copy ready for this issue of the Newsletter, intended to be printed on my return from holiday.

On the Thursday evening, June 20th, my wife was drawing the bedroom curtains and noticed a star moving very slowly in the sky (see report). The following evening, June 21st, I had been to Shaw. On the way home, via High Crompton, I saw a bright light in the sky (see report). **SO DID SEVERAL OTHER PEOPLE.....**I must have more information about this sighting and intend to contact the local press to look into any possible reports. The frustrating part being that as the local holidays started that evening, most of the people were going away and not until after the holidays can any attempt be made to gather this information.

The final twist to these events was on our return home on July 4th (we had told no one about these incidents), there was a letter from a man in Middleton which contained the following....."it was 11.55 p.m. on Thursday night the 21.6.74. I heard the sound of an engine. I got out of bed and looked out of the window. After a few minutes it

showed itself almost like a large bright star. It appeared to fly from the Bolton side and over us in Middleton. It made a right-hand curve or arc in the sky. It must have lasted almost 10 minutes". Ex-policeman.

If anyone has any relevant information of a bright light in the sky on either of the above dates, please send details.

✓ UFO Sightings 20.6.74 - 11.55 p.m. central Rochdale. My wife was drawing the bedroom curtains when she noticed a bright light (like a star) travelling below the clouded sky. The object was travelling away from her; she called me to look and together we watched it for almost half a minute. It continued to travel away from us and finally vanished in the distance. It appeared white to me, but my wife thought it was red and white. Considering its lack of height, it was not an aircraft light. Also there was no sound. Our house lies due east. The object therefore flew southeast away from us. (full detail and map reference available).

✓ UFO SIGHTING 21.6.74 - 11.15 p.m. on the B6194, via High Crompton. As I had passed the sub-P.O. the road rises sharply. On my right, several people were looking up into the sky. Opposite them, a bright glowing object the size of a 1p coin travelled along parallel over the rooftops on my left. It was visible as it passed the gable end of Fitton St. I attempted to keep pace with it (within the legal driving limits). By the time I reach Wood St. it was ahead of me and was still travelling fast. The object was below the cloudy sky. It disappeared over the rooftops of the property at this point. I stopped at the brow of Burnedge Hill and looked back over the whole area. It had now disappeared. (full details and map reference available).
