THE INFERNAL TRIANGLE IS GETTING BOLDER

Although the 'Flying Triangle' (or any other UFO) failed to appear during our May 1st skywatch at Bretby, their numbers have been increasing. The PRA is currently receiving FT information from a wide number of UFO groups, including the 'Cornwall UFO Research Group,' which has recently sent us a number of detailed and well presented investigations.

We have heard from one of our associates Victor J. Kean (Berlin), that the number of 'Flying Triangles' sightings have increased over the Nuclear Power Stations around our coast. Victor has informed us that there has been a 53% increase in sightings over **Bradwell NPS** (1995 - 58 reports & 1996 - 89 reports) and a massive **132% increase** in FT sightings over **Sizewell NPS** (1995 - 65 reports & 1996 - 151 reports).

In spite of all this UFO activity (and remember the FT's are only a part), the general public seem blissfully unaware of what is going on. With the increase in sci-fi movies and TV programmes, the up and coming generation appear to be more susceptible to the idea that 'Aliens' may be visiting our planet. However I was recently asked "are there UFO's over England, I thought they only appeared over the USA?"

As though the UFO subject itself did not have enough pitfalls, we have lately been at the 'sharp end' of inter-group criticism (one individual having been studying the subject for all of 18 months!). We do not intend to get embroiled in such cavilling as our printing space is limited and precious. We would remind everyone of Dr. John E. Mack's thoughts on the subject, *reprinted here from a transcript of a conversation between Dr. Mack and your Editor on the 28th August 1995.*

"We (the UFO community) tend to get fragmented and to argue amongst ourselves. I am interested in how group divisions can be overcome to enable us to become more effective, because I think that this field has a lot to say about human identity, transformation of consciousness, the future of the human species and the relationship of ourselves as spiritual beings in the Universe." "There has been a certain delight that the media have taken, over watching the way that the UFO community have splintered over that film (Santilli/Alien Autopsy). That seems to be such a general phenomena, the way that we end up bickering and fighting among ourselves, so I'm very interested in addressing that."

I believe that we should all remember these words and their implications. Now let us get back to the business of tracking the FT's and learning as much about them as we can. We may even find a clue as to what they are up to!

HINCKLEY SECURITY MAN IN EARLY MORNING ENCOUNTER

Case 97/5 Investigated by new PRA member Mr. M.J.Buchan


In the early hours of the 1st April 1997 a Flying Triangle craft passed over a motor works on the Coventry Road, at Hinckley, Leicestershire.

The time was 0338hrs. when security guard Alan Hydon was on patrol outside the works building. He had paused to look up at the comet Hale-Bopp, with its long tail sweeping across the sky. His attention was suddenly attracted to a pulsating red light in the sky, over in the direction of the nearby Ashby canal. The red glowing light was approaching from the NW and heading on a SW course and was coming closer by the second. It appeared to be low, maybe only 70ft. up.

He became excited and then a little panicky as he realised that this was something highly unusual. The dawn chorus of birdsong suddenly went silent as the red light approached. He heard a low droning sound as it passed over. He also noticed that his guard dog's eyes followed the object as it passed over, something that it never did with local aircraft.

Alan estimated its speed to be about 500mph and it was about the size of a cigarette box at arms length. He was able to make out the clear shape of a dark grey triangle, with a patch of 6 or 7 pulsating red lights, "they went from dull to bright and back again". Alan glanced at his wristwatch and checked the time, he estimated that he could have seen it for just over a minute.

It has passed over and in front of him at an angle of about 70 degrees to the horizon. It was below cloud level and he watched it until it had faded out of sight in the distance. "It was a shape that I had never seen before" said Alan "the sound was most unnatural".




Security Guard Alan Hydon's sketch.



Following a telephone call received at Head Office from the witness (known here under the alias of 'Jane' for privacy reasons) shortly after the sighting, Dave Gillham and Dionne Jones travelled up to Tintagel to interview the witness regarding the sighting of 11th January 1997.

In order to confirm the date, Jane checked with her best friend who she told of the sighting the same day. It occurred at 4 O'clock in the morning on Sunday 11th January this year. Jane was lying in bed and was woken by a star-like object flashing on her wall above the bed in a rhythmic pulse. After watching the light on the wall for a few minutes, Jane realised it was shining into the bedroom from outside, through a gap in the curtains where they didn't close fully.

The rows of red lights were now half the size and had doubled in number; there were now six rows - this was as though both the triangle and red lights had separated. The witness thought she may also have heard voices, even though the windows were closed and she was in the house alone at the time.

Although the lights were very bright, they did not seem to light up the field around them; Jane has often seen the farmers rabbiting with torches and driving the tractor and is familiar with the beams of light from their torches and headlights - the triangle and red lights were not like those lights. Jane then told Dave and Dionne something rather interesting; she admitted that she is involved in 'Lightworking' - this is the

spiritual practice of activating ley lines and energy lines. That evening Jane had been reading an article that told of how to receive 'Christ Light' into various parts of the body - she had asked for that the same evening. She does not know if there is a connection.

The second time Jane went to the window to watch the objects, she watched for a few minutes and once again came away - she admitted that she is not very good at being woken from sleep. Jane then related how she once saw a ghost in an old house in a small mining village out of the county. In her own words she woke up and thought "Oh, right, it's a ghost" and then went straight back to sleep! Describing this incident, the witness claimed that she was not frightened at all.

The next day, Jane spoke to a couple of her friends who live nearby; unfortunately neither of them apparently heard or saw anything that night.

Jane then introduced another intriguing new element to the incident. She said that every-so-often - before this sighting - she would hear from what she describes as 'Lightbeings' who Jane said "seem to be around here". She said that before Christmas she received a message that they were going to be landing in the area and that we should make the people welcome because we were going to "integrate" with them.

When asked how she got the messages, Jane said that she didn't hear a voice but that they appear as ideas in her mind that seem not to be her own. Dave asked if she thought they were telepathic messages and in response Jane said that it was hard for her to say and she always has an element of doubt about the messages - she feels it is not a bad thing to have some doubt. Expanding on this idea, Jane said that over the years she has received messages that have been confirmed in some form; but again she said that she still thinks "Oh, I imagined that".

Dave then said that perhaps what she saw was the landing; Jane said maybe it was, but sounded doubtful - suggesting there is more to follow!

CONCLUSION

Whilst conducting the investigation, Dave and Dionne studied the field in which the event was said to have taken place. No physical evidence of the objects could be found; this suggests either the objects had very little mass or were not in contact with the ground, hovering just above it.

The witness herself subsequently made some enquiries to the owner of the field and informed Dave that all he was aware of in the vicinity of the field was a car crash on the road - however, this does not explain the strange lights in the field; nor was the witness aware of any event of this type during her sighting.

The witness seemed very genuine and truthful; the way in which she talked about other strange experiences in her life suggests that she is telling the truth. The fact that she appears to have some psychic ability (seeing the ghost) and an interest in

other areas of the paranormal (lightworking) leads one to entertain the idea that the sighting was somehow connected to this. Furthermore, Jane's statement that we are to "integrate" with the "Lightbeing" people is very similar to statements made by many contactees and abductees worldwide.




Following a Press Release about the Tintagel triangle appearing in local papers (see Report No. 4), CUFORG Head Office received a telephone call from someone in Bodmin reporting a similar sighting at Polzeath beach. Dave Gillham took some details over the telephone and arranged to interview the witnesses on the 15th February 1997.

On that day he and Newquay investigator Elaine Darlington went to the witnesses house to speak to the young lady and her boyfriend who both saw the phenomena. The witnesses are known as the aliases of 'Sue' and 'Peter' for privacy reasons.

Sue told Dave and Elaine that she and her boyfriend were walking along Polzeath beach at around eight in the evening on the 5th February 1997; suddenly in front of them appeared a large white triangle with a smaller one attached to the back of it.

The triangles seemed to be descending towards the water and when the tip touched the water they just disappeared. Sue said that the triangles appeared flat, without any three-dimensional aspects.



Sue and Peter were halfway along the beach, level with a red van advertising a surf shop, as well as the portacabins that are there; they estimated the object to be no more than twelve feet from their position and barely two feet off the ground. The size of the objects was estimated to be twenty feet along each side for the larger triangle, with the smaller one almost exactly half that size.

Dave asked if they recall which direction the objects appeared from and they were both adamant that they just appeared in front of them. They started over the beach and slowly moved towards the water; as they reached the waters edge they

disappeared. The objects were said to have moved fairly slowly and were seen for about ten seconds before disappearing.

Immediately prior to the sighting, Sue said that they heard a noise that scared her quite badly. Dave asked what sort of noise they heard - it was a long, mumbled cry for help. They both looked around frantically but could see no one that the call could have come from. A few moments later the objects appeared. Sue doesn't know if this was connected to the lights but gave the impression she thought so as there was no one else around at the time.

After further questioning, it was determined that the objects appeared in front of the couple, travelled in a straight line towards the water and rather than flying off simply ceased to be there any longer. As soon as the objects disappeared they looked up in the sky and could see nothing.

Sue said that there were very few other lights in the vicinity and the triangles did not light up the area around them - it was just the triangles themselves that were bright. The light was said to be white, as bright as a light bulb; it was constant, with no pulsing or other flashing lights visible. Sue said that the light did not hurt her eyes. She said that it was a fascinating sight and made her think "Wow, oh my God!" - she seemed drawn to look at it and afterwards they both asked each other if they had really seen what they saw.

Trying to confirm whether the object(s) had any dimensional qualities, Elaine asked them again if they were sure it was very flat. They were quite certain that it was. Further questioning confirmed that it was very low; Sue said it was just above the floor and Peter added that it was hovering just above the ground.

Following the sighting, the couple were quite shaken and excited - a fact subsequently backed up by Sue's mother during the interview who said they were "full of it" on returning - they hurriedly went back to their car and drove home.

In response to the question what did they think it was, neither person could offer an explanation. Sue said that it didn't look like a "spaceship that you see on your catalogue" (referring to the CUFORG Newsletter Dave had given her at the beginning of the interview).

Elaine then asked if either of them had suffered any effects as a result of the sighting, such as itching eyes - neither Sue nor Peter recall any physical effects either during or after the sighting. Responding to the question of whether either of them had experienced any psychic phenomena in the past, neither of them had.

CONCLUSION

After the interview Dave, Elaine and myself (Ian Darlington) made our way to Polzeath beach to investigate the site. As could have been expected there were no physical traces evident. We easily found the position the couple were when they encountered the objects and were surprised to find the area less remote than expected.

Skywatch Diary

As mentioned in last week's Skywatch Diary, there has been a lot of UFO activity in neighboring Baldwin County, Alabama. The cattle mutilation that was reported in January has been followed by on going sightings including a daylight sighting approximately one half mile from the mutilation site. Investigators Clopton and Sue Jones who live in Foley, Alabama have been keeping me abreast of developments and I received the following report from Clopton this week.

At approximately 11 p.m. on Tuesday, April 8th, a young couple were driving on Hwy. 32, approximately six miles west of Summerdale, Alabama when they observed a bright light not too high in the sky ahead of them. The 21-year old man borrowed a camcorder from his girlfriend's mother in the hope of capturing the UFO on video if it appeared again. Three hours later, around 2 a.m. on the morning of Wednesday, April 9th, the man spotted the UFO northwest of his home. He shot some very clear video, including some outstanding close ups of the craft. The UFO appears to be swaying like a falling leaf, the underside of the craft appears illuminated. The craft is cone shaped with white and green lights below and red flashing lights on either side. On Wednesday, April 9th, at approximately 11 p.m. the UFO was observed again. The witness was able to obtain more video footage, which shows a dark cone-shaped object with a flashing red light on top.

The story of these sightings was carried by The Robertsdale Independent and Fairhope Courier and as previously mentioned, some of the video footage and accompanying interviews were featured on the WKRG TV5 (local CBS affiliate) news on April 23rd. Coverage was factual as to the events and the report was not done from a skeptical or sarcastic viewpoint, as is so often the case. Clopton Jones states that the newspaper reporter and Channel 5 newsman were both very impressed by the video and seemed to have no reservations whatsoever about the reality of it.

Events continued on Thursday, April 24th at 9:15 p.m. when the witness' mother and sister observed a stationary, or very slow moving "white-orangish" light in the southwestern sky near their home. There was a lot of air traffic in the area at the time, but the light appeared at a higher altitude than the 'planes. The witness was called outside to observe the light, but was unable to make any video recording since the camcorder had been returned to it's owner earlier in the day. The witness left to purchase film in the hope of capturing some still photographs of the UFO. At 11:15 p.m. the witness and his mother observed the craft again to the east of their position. It was at least as close as when the witness had video recorded the craft previously. The witness took several photographs using 200 speed film and an inexpensive camera. It was a clear, bright night, and one of the pictures shows a craft which seems to be identical to the one photographed by Ed Walters and featured on the cover of the book "The Gulf Breeze Sightings" by Ed and Frances Walters. They observed the craft until it disappeared before their eyes "like a light being turned off".

The investigation of these events is ongoing and the events are reported here for information purposes only. The validity of the photographs and video will hopefully be examined in the coming weeks and I will make every effort to continue to report events as they unfold. There are several other reports of sightings during the months of March and April this year in the Baldwin County area, some of which will be included in next week's Skywatch Diary. This is an interesting series of events that certainly warrant further investigation and I wish to express my sincere thanks to Clopton and Sue Jones for relaying these reports to me.

The Evening Sky

May 1997

The Southern sky is so exciting because it is in that part of the heavens where all the planets and the Moon can be seen. However, our emotions are usually more intense when we look East or West, the twilight window between day and night. The window opens at dawn and dusk and the colours in the sky can take your breath away, especially when a thin crescent Moon is rising (May 9th).

We feel the seasons come and go by witnessing the rising and setting of the Sun and noticing the different star constellations. The patterns, rhythms, circles and cycles of nature change relentlessly, and were familiar to our ancestors in a way that they are not today. We are separated from nature by millions of years of evolution and by thousands of years of so called civilisation. We have lost much.

People often tell me the Western sky appears more active, perhaps because people are awake in the evening. This is not good enough and you must stay out overnight, at least one night, in May. Wrap up warm, lie on a sun-bed so that you are facing the heavens and watch the stars roll by. When the dawn twilight bursts forth, I guarantee you will be overcome with wonder and astonishment at nature.

Comet Hale-Bopp is fast disappearing. The tail is now pointing away from the Earth and will appear very short even though in reality, it is millions of miles long. Look for the comet on May 6th because it is travelling through the Earth's orbital path, a position the Earth will occupy in January 1998!



Worlds above the Galaxy

The golden/orange point of light shining high in the Southern sky at evening twilight is the planet Mars. Mars is growing dimmer as the Earth leaves Mars behind, as we orbit the Sun.

You cannot see Uranus, Neptune or Pluto with the naked eye. A good pair of binoculars will allow observation of Uranus and Neptune but you will need a good 8 or 10 inch telescope to see Pluto. Pluto is only 1,400 miles in diameter and is 3.5 billion miles distance from Earth. You will also need a good star map to locate these three distant planets.

The BBC's 'Sky at Night' programme presented by Patrick Moore has just celebrated its 40th anniversary. It is the longest running television Astronomy programme in the world. I particularly like the theme music 'At the Castle Gate' by Sibelius. This music is much better than all this computer-generated, atonal, techno-dance music which is so fashionable today and which drives me utterly crazy with its electronic beat!

A Full Moon occurs on May 23rd. Do not stay out all night on this night as Moonlight shadows can play funny tricks with your imagination.

UFO SIGHTINGS OVER NOTTINGHAM.

DUNKIRK

On the 3rd of April (1997), Mr Glyn Hickling was walking his dog at about 21:15 in the Dunkirk area of Nottingham. Mr Hickling was watching the comet Hale-Bop when a red light caught his eye. As it approached and descended on one of the busiest parts of Nottingham's road systems, Mr Hickling saw that the red light was followed by three other identical lights. They were equally spaced and glowed the same deep red colour. They levelled off at about 250 feet at which point they were passing over Mr Hickling, he waited for the sound of the engines and became confused when there was none. The distant traffic would not have drowned a light aircrafts engine from the location the witness was at.

All four craft appeared as balls of red light, but at their closest point they were disc shaped. As the objects passed silently overhead, they started to gain height and move over to their right. Mr Hickling noticed on the back disc slightly above the red body shape, a tiny white light which he said was part of the craft itself.

Mr Hickling stated that the most amazing thing about the sighting was the total lack of noise.

BESTWOOD PARK

Three days later on the 6th April, one of my investigators Mr Karl Barnes and myself, were standing outside Mr Barnes house when we noticed a very distant white light travelling across the night sky. The comet was visible and so were several stars. We also tracked four airliners at the same time and their flashing lights were very observable. The airliners seemed to be travelling across the sky very slowly compared to the white light that we were watching.

The white light didn't flash at any time and travelled about twice as fast as the airliners. It was about 21:00 hours and the last glow of daylight could be seen on the horizon. This light travelled from East to West.

Before the light disappeared, an identical light appeared from the South and travelled North. Again there were no flashing light on this light and it appeared to be about the same height as the other. We assume that the light was self illuminating because the only reason we could see the airliners, was because of their flashing lights.

GEDLING

On the night of the 8th of April, Mr and Mrs Dunn of Gedling, were watching the comet from their bedroom window late at night when they noticed a strange white light in the distance.

The couple were looking out towards Gedling Colliery and the open countryside. At first, they didn't know if the light was stationary or moving, but under careful observation they saw that it was moving very slowly. The light was travelling above the horizon some distance away when it suddenly shot straight up into the air and became stationary. The height gained was estimated to be about one mile in two seconds.

Mrs Dunn then noticed a small distant aircraft passing the vicinity that the light was first seen at. Once the small plane had flew away, the strange light then slowly descended to its original position and then carried on along its flight path until it went out of sight.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS OF THE PSYCHIC KIND

April 17th 1993

After retiring to bed, I soon fell into a deep sleep, it was some time later that my vision began.

I opened my eyes and I was inside what appeared to be a control room of some sort, in an enormous flying machine. I knew we were in flight because I could feel the movement of the craft beneath my feet. There was a loud humming sound coming from somewhere far below me. The room was ablaze with light, a blue fluorescent haze pressed into every corner, it pulsed with a strange hypnotic rhythm like a heartbeat, I felt it inside my head, beating in time with my own heart.

The light grew brighter and brighter with every second and bathed me in its radiance. I felt that I was suspended in a blue void, floating aimlessly on a gentle tranquil sea. My conscious self was lost in the unimaginable beauty of this unexplored domain. Very gradually, I experienced a complete inner peace, the like of which I had never known before. I felt myself sinking slowly down and down into what looked like a huge whirlpool of colours. They flickered and danced before my eyes in a never ending display of hues and changing patterns. The room was, as far as I could determine, oval shaped and blue throughout. There was a large control console standing in the centre of the cabin. It was about ten feet long and four feet high. It had a mass of weird coloured lights on its top and some were flashing in some sort of sequence. There were three thickly padded seats positioned in front of the console and on the left of this was what I could only describe as an illuminated cubicle about six feet in height. On the right was a hatch or doorway and about fifteen feet in front of me I could see three human figures. They were standing by a large viewing monitor, watching a transmission of some description. They were totally unaware of my presence, but I was strangely drawn towards them, as though there was a special bond between us, but I didn't know what it was. The crew members were busily pointing out items of interest on the screen, then eventually the transmission came to an end. They spoke to each other in what sounded like English, but I was not close enough to hear what they were saying. I walked slowly and hesitatingly towards, a little nervous and unsure of myself.

If I had expected to see beautiful, graceful creatures with the wisdom and intellect of countless ages, then I would have been disappointed. Instead, there were three ordinary, but colourful individuals standing before me. The leader was a little taller than his two companions, he was about six feet tall and very slender. His head was normal in size to my own and his hair was shoulder length and reddish brown in colour. Around his forehead he wore a broad silver band, with two small static lights on each side. His eyes were piercing blue in colour and of

normal size, as were his nose and ears. His mouth was long and there was a slight blue tinge over his thin lips. His whole complexion had a bronzed appearance, much like suntan. Although his features could not be described as handsome, his face was of a gentle nature.

He was dressed in a grey uniform with a high collar and three quarter length sleeves and on the front of his uniform was a small pouch type pocket with an insignia on it. It was like a silver circle with the letter M or W on its side, positioned in the centre. The other crew members were dressed more or less identically, with the same colour uniforms and emblems. Both were male, one with blonde hair and the other light brown. They all wore the same type of boots, dark grey, with a blue stripe across the front.


