FLYING TRIANGLE ACTIVITY INCREASING WORLDWIDE

With the assistance of modern technology we are now able to exchange information rapidly with countries throughout the World.

The reports reports of UFO's ebb and flow from one area to another, with various local groups exclaiming that 'they' have a 'UFO Hot Spot' and are therefore the centre of UFO attention! However it is becoming increasingly obvious that FT's (Flying Triangles) are appearing in more locations and with more frequency than is generally realised.

'Project FT' is a Flying Triangle research organisation that has logged many hundreds of 'Flying Triangle' incidents for many years and also George A. Filer (Director Mutual UFO Network -USA) has frequently reported FT incidents from many parts of the world.

In recent issues of his 'Filers Files' George A. Filer has reported the following cases:

Rockford, Illinois. June 30th 2002, the witness was on his way to bed when he looked out of his patio door and saw four lights in the sky. Three of the lights were white and bright and formed a Flying Triangle longer than wide. There was one light at each corner . A red light was in the middle towards the back. The object was heading Northeast in a slightly circling line of travel and moving at about 30mph. (*Thanks to Peter Davenport NUFORC*)

Mabton, Washington. The two objects flew very slowly and came towards us in a Southwest direction on **June 26,2002**. As they came closer at 10.50pm, we saw four lights on the objects...The Flying Triangles made a low and quiet rumble as they came closer. After ten minutes they turned Northeast and I saw three green lights on the back of both objects with a flashing light on the right side. (NUFORC)

Naples, Florida. The witness was travelling on interstate 75, eleven miles south of Naples on Friday morning **March 1st 2002**. He noticed an object over to his left, with three white lights and it came over at a very slow pace. The witness said "I was able to make out the shape very distinctly as a low Flying Triangle".

Sebastian, Florida. The witness and his wife saw a grey Flying Triangle around 7.30pm with no lights or sound travelling very fast over East Central Florida on **March 11th 2002**.

Cleburne, Texas. Jason greywolf Leigh reports that on **March 14th 2002**, about 8.40pm his sight was drawn to a huge white non-glaring light, slightly smaller than the full moon.....Jason drove toward the object that compared to the Super Dome in New Orleans, or about 400/500ft across and about 200/300ft high.

One Flying Triangle flap that has apparently attracted little attention, has been occurring once more in the country of Belgium. According to the latest information received and published in the SOBEPS magazine 'Inforespace', there was extensive 'Flying Triangle' activity in that country during the latter end of 2001.

We have included a report and a number of drawings concerned with this activity, in this issue of the OVNI. Unfortunately we have been unable to include full details of the 2001 'Mini-Wave' but we will endeavour to produce a more detailed report in the next issue.

UFO LIGHTS SEEN OVER MELBOURNE COULD HAVE BEEN TWO 'FLYING TRIANGLES'!

A report in our previous issue covered the sighting of what appeared to be diamond shaped lights over Melbourne by Mr Brian Hampson on the night of the 13th March this year. The lights were seen at around 9.40pm and were reported to be heading WSW.

We have now received a report from a Mrs S.M. Whittle who saw 'FT' lighted craft while driving with her daughter along the Burton Road at Repton at 9.45pm on the night of the 13th March, just a few minutes after the sighting by Mr Hampson.

Mrs Whittle states: "Whilst driving along the Burton Road, and heading towards Repton, my daughter observed two bright objects in the sky."

"We stopped the car and I got out to look. The two objects looked like (see drawing) travelling towards Burton. There a lot of bright individual lights under each one."


"They travelled side by side, then one behind the other and then one on top of each other, then just vanished!"

"The colour of the lights was a bright white/yellow and they were in a triangular shape. There was no sound and the shape was sharply defined."

When replying to the question: What was unusual about the sighting that made you think the object was not natural or man-made. Mrs Whittle replied "The objects were not on the normal (East Midlands) plane path, also the shape was unusual and the way they moved and changed positions." The manner in which the craft "just disappeared" and the changing of the crafts position is unusual.

At the time of the sighting given as 9.45pm (Mrs Whittle checked her clock when she arrived at home shortly afterwards) there was a clear sky and the conditions were cold and dry, with the stars visible.

The observation time of the sighting was put down as five minutes, but was probably considerably less, even though the FT's were described as moving "Slow". The size of the craft when viewed by the witness was given as 3 inches diameter, which indicated that they were probably quite low and in the order of 1,000/2000ft.

MORE LIGHTS AROUND MELBOURNE (Derbyshire)

All the indications are that Melbourne is becoming a centre of UFO activity! There appears to be no explanation as to why this area has been having more than its fair share of UFO sightings.

The latest report concerns an incident that took place on the night of the 26th May 02 at 10.30pm near Stanton-by-Bridge and was witnessed by Mrs Diane Foss who was travelling in a car being driven by her 17 year old son.

Mrs Foss related what happened:

We left Melbourne at 10.15pm on the 26th May 02. After driving around the town for ten minutes or so, we headed home.

On rounding a bend in the road near to Stanton-by-Bridge, I noticed an unusual light formation in the sky ahead of us. My son pulled the car over to the side of the road and switched off the engine and wound down the side windows, but there was not a sound!

The object remained in the same position ahead of us. There was one object, made up of a group of very bright red and white lights in a vertical position, one above the other. There was complete silence and no obvious movement. The size was about that of a 2p piece at arms length. There was no sign of any other air traffic at that time or any other motor vehicles on the road.

My son and I looked at each other, saying "Bloody Hell" and then we looked back. In those few seconds the object had vanished!

My son then drove the car up to higher ground nearer to Ticknell and then parked. There was no sign of the light formation that we had seen, only the usual aircraft leaving the nearby East Midlands Airport.

At the time, it was a dry, cool evening, with the Moon and stars being visible.

The lights were first seen as we rounded a bend in the road near Swarkestone bridge. It was then that the object became visible, while hovering in the sky. The lights were at an angle of about 45 degrees and in a Northwest direction. We watched them for about one to two minutes and noted that they were in a vertical position, red on white, on red with on sound or obvious movement, before they suddenly disappeared.

ANOTHER UFO LIGHT OVER 'BONSALL'

(26-3-2002)

On the night of the 26th March 02 at 5.55pm Mr Ronald Mounthey of the High Street, Bonsall, had been working outside in his garden . He was just about to return indoors when he noticed a hazy yellowy/orange light slowly approaching from the East.

There was no sound associated with the light, which was described as round and of a hazy, medium intensity.


“At first it came towards us from the East” stated Mr Mounthey. “We watched it for about 30 minutes as it hovered at an angle of about 40 degrees. At the time the weather was fine, with some scattered cloud and the Moon was visible Then after some time, it went away in the same direction, getting higher and smaller.”

Ed: Mr Mounthey lives only a mile or so from the home of Mrs Sharon Rowlands, famous for the international coverage given to the claim that she had been paid £20,000 for her UFO video footage.

The report from Mr Mounthey resembles the Rowlands incident, although that took place over a shorter time period.

Mr Mounthey has also supplied the PRA with a photograph of the incident, which shows the location drawn by him and reproduced below.

The supplied photograph basically, shows the moon with a small light source near it. The photo, taken without the use of a telephoto lens, only confirms the details of the sketch.

A UFO INCIDENT NEAR BUXTON 23-6-2002

We have received a report from a Mr H.A. Hardwick concerning an incident that occurred at approx. 9.30pm on the 23rd June this year.

Mr Hardwick was driving in his car, leaving Buxton via the Market Place and proceeding towards Ashbourne. He stopped at the A515 traffic lights junction, crossing the A6.

While he was stationary in his car something strange occurred. Mr Harwick relates "Suddenly a brilliant light appeared to the SW over the village of Harper Hill. It was a brilliant, glittering golden light - the whole 'object' was illuminated. The shape seemed to be as tall as it was wide, with no clear defined edges. The light was not white, but it was a brilliant glittering gold in colour. The whole thing glowed! It was stationary for a while and then it moved a little way to the S.E."

Mr Hardwick continued "The clouds were thick, black and low. The object had stopped briefly, then ascended vertical at great speed into the black clouds. The incident must have lasted 30 seconds."

When asked about his opinion as to why the object did not have a natural explanation or was not thought to be man made, Mr Hardwick replied: "The size and the glittering mass. The main feature was the great light of glittering golden colour. The whole mass of the object was illuminated. It was spectacular for a brief time."

A SIGHTING NEAR CROMFORD (Derbys.)

A Mr Wilson telephoned to report that at 11.45pm on the night of the 12th June this year, he had been travelling in a car on the A632 and was passing near Kelstedge, Nr Ashover, when he saw a big stationary red ball of light in the sky.

The light was similar to a sodium street lamp and was very big. He estimated that the light was hovering at a height of about 1,500ft.

It then moved off in the direction of Mansfield (Easterly).



ANOTHER FLYING TRIANGLE 'FLAP' IN BELGIUM?

An edited report from 'inforespace' the SOBEPs magazine.

It is only possible to give a general picture of what has been happening in Belgium, the details are as follows:

During the evening of the 1st September 2001 Mr 'W.D.' a consultant for the EEC was driving on the E411 autoroute (Brussels/Ardennes). It was about 2130hrs. when he saw several points of intense white light in the sky. At the time he was in the area of 'Aire de Nil-Saint-Martin' (a landscaped rest/parking area). He was able to see that there were three points of white light in the shape of a triangle (see sketch).

The lights were on the corners of a massive isoscles triangular craft




Fig. 01 - 01.09.2001 - Observation de W.D.




Fig. 02 - 06.12.2001 - Observation de Y.S.





Fig. 03 - 19.12.2001 - Observation de Y.S.




Fig. 08 - 23.12.2001 - Observation de L.D.




Fig. 09 - 23.12.2001 - Observation de S.B. (épouse de L.D.)

VIRGINIA FLYING TRIANGLE

VIRGINIA BEACH -- The witness reports that on June 6, 2002, "I went to meet a friend for a walk on the board walk to observe the storm coming in at 8:15 PM, and we looked at the southern gray sky and saw a black flying triangular object in the sky." At first I thought it was a plane, but realized that it did not move. This black triangle occupied exactly the same spot in the sky while I walked two blocks, and stopped a neighbor and asked her if she saw something, she looked and said, "What is it?" I said I don't know, she decided it was a kite. The object had not moved and was high enough for the clouds to occasionally pass between the object and the ground. In the next 5 minutes the stormy sky became too dark to see the object. The black flying triangle had silently hovered at cloud level for ten minutes before the darkness and storm obscured it. NEVADA ORANGE GLOWING FLYING TRIANGLE

LAS VEGAS -- The witness reports that on June 6, 2002, a glowing orange light was seen at 10:30 PM. We watched it disappear then reappear three times over a sixty-second period before going behind the mountains. The last time we saw it, the orange glow was coming from three orange lights in a triangular shape. The object was large and had mass but there was no sound.

(Peter Davenport reports, "This was the date that 'The Amazing Kreskin,' predicted a dramatic UFO sighting would occur over Nevada. On June 7, 2002, he retracted, and stated that the "prediction" had been a hoax, designed to show how gullible human beings can be regarding the UFO phenomenon. ARKANSAS DAYLIGHT CYLINDER

LONSDALE -- Richard B. Baccari writes, "I live in rural town and have been watching the sky since my mother had a sighting 30 years ago. Until today I was always able to explain whatever I had seen. I was pulling into my road at 3:55 PM, on June 14, 2002, and just happened to glance at the clear sky and saw a white bar or cylinder. I could only see two dimensions. At arm's length it was the width of two fingers and the thickness half a finger. It was definitely close enough to establish that there was no wing, tail, window, or rotor configuration. It was just plain dull white and was not a reflective surface? It made me think cylinder as it was traveling east very slowly without making any noise. It flew over in less than a minute. A DUTCH CORNFIELD MYSTERY IN GELDERLAND 7-6-2002

On the 7th June this year, we received a phone call from a farmer who told us that he had seen a 200 metre trail of cut-off corn plants (in his field). He also told us that there were no footprints whatsoever.

Once we arrived at the field, we saw that the farmer was right, there were absolutely no footprints whatever, except for the footprints of the farmer himself. He had walked some distance away from the trail as he didn't want to damage the (cut-off) trail for our research.

One strange detail was the fact that it looked as though the (cut-off) trail had stayed wetter than the rest of the field. It had rained the previous night, but the sun was shining now and the field was starting to dry, but the (cut-off) trail was still wet.


Most parts (cut-off tops) of the plants were next to the plants (in the ground), but in some cases we couldn't find the cut-off pieces. There were also some cut-off tops that were standing in the soil next to the cut-off plants (in the ground). It looked as if someone had put them into the ground.

Another strange fact was that some of the cut-off parts were almost dried up. It looks as if these parts were cut off some days before, because the farmer told us that during the weather that week, these plants would have dried out in approx. 3 - 4 days. Therefore we formed the opinion that the trail had been formed at two different times.

The PTAH Foundation is keeping an eye on this field to see if anything else is going to happen.

VANISHING ESKIMOS

From Tom Slemen's Mysterious World

In November 1930, Joe Labelle, a Canadian fur trapper, snow shoed into a thriving Eskimo fishing village situated on the shores of lake Anjikuni in Canada.

Labelle was greeted with an eerie silence. He thought this was very strange because the fishing village was a noisy settlement with 2,000 Eskimos milling back and forth to their kayaks. But there wasn't a soul about.

Labelle visited each of the Eskimo huts and fish storehouses but none of the villagers was anywhere to be seen. Labelle saw a flickering fire in the distance and approached it gingerly, sensing something evil was afoot on this moonlight night. Upon the fire was a smouldering pot of blackened stew. To make matters more mysterious, Labelle saw that not a single human track had left the settlement.

Labelle knew that something bizarre had happened to the 2,000 people and so he ran non-stop to the nearest telegraph office and sent a message about his findings to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. The 'mounties' turned up hours later and they too were baffled by the mass vanishing act.

An enormous search party was sent out to look for the missing villagers, but they were never found and the search party unearthed some strange findings. All the sleigh dogs that had belonged to the Eskimos were found buried 12 feet under a snowdrift at the perimeter of the camp. All of them had starved to death.

The search party also established that the Eskimo's provisions and food had been left in their huts, which didn't make any sense at all. Then came the most chilling surprise of all; the search party discovered that all of the Eskimos' ancestral graves were empty. Whoever or whatever had taken all the living villagers had also dug up the dead as well, even though the icy ground around the graves was as hard as iron.

Later on that unearthly silent night, the mounties watched in awe as a strange blue glow lit up the horizon. The eerie radiance was not the northern lights, but seemed steady and artificial. As the mounties watched, the light pulsed then faded.

All the newspapers in the World reported the baffling disappearance of the 2,000 Eskimos, although many believed that a rational explanation would eventually come to light, but the Anjikuni mass disappearance is still unsolved.

1992 LOCAL MYSTERY

We have been told that 10 years ago a retired couple were driving down Radbourne Lane (Derby) and were about to take the L/H turning to Melbourne, when the driver glanced in his mirror and was amazed to see a 'Flying Saucer' following their car. It followed them for only a short time, before moving away and out of sight.

Shortly after the incident, the driver returned with a friend to inspect the area and they found a number of circles burned in the road, measuring 20/30 yards. Each circle had a smaller circle in the centre (about the size of a car tyre) with a 'dot' in the centre. The witnesses concerned, told only a few people of the incident. One was a sub-contractor for Rolls-Royce involved in the photographic inspection of metals. This person happened to be visiting Kodak a short time afterwards and mentioned the circle in the road incident to a colleague. He was told that Kodak had a room full of photographs showing similar events!

Ed. Is it just another story? We can take it or leave it, but it is often the case that reports of this nature slot another piece of the UFO jigsaw into place.

Bonsall UFO meeting



Our UFO expert, Omar Fowler, reports from a meeting in Bonsall which explored the idea of UFOs visiting the area.

In view of the widespread interest in the UFO activity taking place in and around the Derbyshire village of Bonsall, a group of UFO researchers headed by Graham Birdsall, the editor of 'UFO Magazine', decided to hold a public meeting in the village hall, on Wednesday 26th June.

The meeting, which had been arranged mainly for the convenience of the local Bonsall residents, attracted a number of visitors from Mansfield, Nottingham and as far away as Preston.

Graham Birdsall of 'Quest International' and the Editor of 'UFO Magazine' had travelled down from Leeds with his colleague **Russell Gallagher**, an expert in video and photographic analysis.

Graham Birdsall opened the meeting with a general history of the UFO phenomenon, touching on the initial sighting of a flight of UFO's by pilot Kenneth Arnold on the 24th June 1947.

Kenneth had been interviewed by reporters when he landed.

It was then that he described the unknown craft he had seen as being "like saucers skipping across water", and so the term 'Flying Saucers' was born.

Graham also gave details of discussions that he has had with various scientists during his visits to venues around the World. These had ranged from Australia to the Hawaii Islands.

Nearer to home, Omar Fowler, the Group Leader of the Phenomenon Research Association (Derby) gave

details of the very latest UFO sighting on the 23rd June, in the Buxton area.

He also touched on the large number of UFO reports received from the Bonsall residents.

Omar then went on to introduce the audience to the subject of the relatively new UFO phenomenon, the 'Flying Triangles'.

The 'FT' craft were illustrated by means of witnesses drawings and a video of an 'FT' encounter at Shirebrook, near Mansfield on 23rd August of 1994.

Mr Tony James of the East Midlands group (EMUFORA), showed videos and photographs of UFO's taken in the Gulf Breeze area of Florida USA.

He also gave a detailed account of his meeting with local Gulf Breeze resident Ed Walters and the amazing Polaroid photographs that he had taken in the area.

Finally Russell Gallagher, showed a wide range of video clips which demonstrated the pitfalls of filming with an 'automatic' camcorder.

He also demonstrated how camcorders had produced some amazing UFO footage from various parts of the world.

The meeting finally drew to a close with a wide range of questions from the audience to the panel of UFO researchers.

The local residents then made their way home, treading carefully in the darkness and keeping one eye on the sky!

BBC RADIO DERBY COVERAGE OF THE RECENT BONSCALL MEETING

The above article appeared on the BBC Radio Derby web-page and covered this piece of local Derbyshire news.

The meeting had been arranged by Graham Birdsall (Editor of UFO Magazine) in an attempt to redress the negative result of the recent Aetherius meeting at the Bonsall Village Hall, when several local residents walked out in disgust at the content of the meeting.

A full report of the meeting was given by Anthony James (EMUFORA) on his UFO web-page.

Tony described how some of the locals' had been angered at what they considered to be the quasi-religious presentation given by the Aetherius Society.

The Evening Sky July 2002

Venus is the only planet conspicuous during July's long evening twilights. Look west about half-an-hour after the Sun has set and see Venus shining quite low in the fading light.

The other four naked eye planets, though visible briefly are really lost in the glare of the Sun for most of this month. Jupiter and Mars may be spotted in the early evening, close to the western horizon while Mercury and Saturn may be spotted just before dawn, close to the eastern horizon.

The Earth is farthest away from the Sun on July 6. Astronomers call this aphelion. The centre of the Earth will be 94,507,073 miles from the centre of the Sun on that date. The Earth is over 3 million miles farther from the Sun in the middle of our summer than it is in the middle of our winter. The Earth's seasons are not created by the distance of the Earth from the Sun but by the tilt of the Earth's axial spin to the plane of the solar system. While orbiting the Sun, Earth's axial tilt faces (summer) and looks away (winter) from the Sun thus creating our wonderful seasons.

A rather dim meteor shower peaks around July 28: the Northern Delta Aquarids. The Aquarids are rich in faint meteors making it suitable for binocular observation although a few brighter meteors exist to make naked eye observation worth the effort. A more southerly site is better than the British Isles.

Full moon occurs on July 24. July Moon names are: Hay Moon, Wort Moon, Blessing Moon, Fallow Moon, and Thunder Moon.

The Romans called July (their fifth month) 'Quintilis', but later renamed it Julius after Julius Caesar. The Greek Olympiad was held for about a week in July. This festival, in honour of Zeus, consisted of competitions in athletics, drama, music, and other activities.

The world of astrophysics is a-buzz at the moment with the possible discovery of a 'Quark Star'. However, first let us recap our knowledge on the bizarre and extreme. A neutron star consists of a liquid sea of neutrons, the remains of crushed atomic nuclei packed so densely that a teaspoonful would weigh about one billion tons on Earth - very heavy indeed!

The pressure at the core of a neutron star might be great enough to crush even the neutrons apart into their constituent particles (called 'quarks'). This would increase the density of the matter within the star and shrink the star considerably. A quark star of several solar masses would be less than 9 miles in diameter. The discovery of this super dense star supports this current theoretical model of particle physics.
