THE LANGWITH 'HOT SPOT' COMES TO LIFE AGAIN!

PRA member 'Neil' has been in constant touch with us, concerning the continuing activity in the Langwith, Mansfield area of Nottinghamshire. Neil has taken numerous camcorder shots of the strange lights seen near his home.

Readers may recollect that this Langwith is adjacent to Shirebrook (Notts.) where there was a sensational 'Flying Triangle' event on the night of the 23rd August 1994, when Mr Daryl Spence and a friend decided to hold a skywatch on top of an old coal tip.

They were amazed to witness a glowing 'FT' approaching at high speed, then en route, release a small globe of light and then hover over the area while at the same time, emitting a brilliant illumination.

The whole event was captured by Daryl on his camcorder, complete with a blaspheming sound track, but even more sensational was the sound and shortly afterwards the navigation lights of two approaching helicopters, seen heading straight for the hovering 'FT'.

As they drew closer, the brightly illuminated craft suddenly blinked out and apparently disappeared from view. The helicopters flew around the area for a while and then flew off.

This whole event was captured by Daryl on video and remains one of the most amazing sequences filmed to date of a UFO encounter!

When questioned about the event, the M.O.D. commented that there had been "no aerial activity in that area at that time"!

Neil has drawn two excellent sketches of the events that he witnessed on page 3 and 4.

On page 3, Neil describes the low, pulsating intermittent, reverberating sound of the FT ("like a swarm of bees"). He also describes the red and white lights seen flashing along the edge of the craft. He went on to explain that as the craft changed its position, he could see the belly of the craft, but then only the white lights could be seen.

Most prominent were the two red lights seen close to the front of the craft (see page 3).

An event witnessed by Neil on the night of the 24th March 08 is illustrated on page 4, with a bright white light so brilliant that "it was difficult to look at" is described, plus the appearance of a bright red and white light. Neil's son also witnessed a number of these events.

It is a mystery why people in the area didn't flock out of their homes to witness this spectacular event, but with the very cold nights and the time of the event (10pm) there were probably few people out and about at that time.





Low pulsating intermittent reverberating sound, like a swarm of bees a bit like a transformer. Once you hear it, you never forget it.

Red & white lights flashing along edge of craft, most be in some form of recess. When craft drops and alters angle of view, now looking at the belly, only the white lights can be seen, over shadowed by edge of craft. Difficult to view properly, dark craft against dark horizon, so I concentrated on the two red lights at the front of the craft. That's when I hear the sound when it's in the second position.

Are 'Flying Triangles' The Result Of New 'Stealth' Technology

Nice to hear from you. I just wanted to follow up on at least one of the flying triangle cases. You may recall the January 5th 2000 case. One strong possibility comes to mind. What was sighted over Southern Illinois in January of 2000 may have been a test flight of a joint Northrop/McDonnell Douglas (Teledyne Ryan subcontractor) bi-static radar LTA craft that used a hybrid electro-gravitic propulsion system (reference low hum heard by at least one police officer).

This particular craft uses a carbon fiber exo-skeleton, in conjunction with an advanced Kevlar exterior. You will recall that the TR-3A that flew with the F-117's during desert storm has never been declassified (that also goes for the two sub-scale Northrop B-2's which have never seen the light of day). Also reference the 1982-1989 Hudson Valley flying triangle sightings where electro-magnetic disruptions were reported which included static on car radios, and engines shutting down. I'm guessing the 1989 crash of a base forward flying triangle on the East German border (see YOUTUBE presentation key-word: Michael Schratt) may have used a similar propulsion system.

This particular craft had a crew of two, and had the capability of hovering as well as split second extremely high speed acceleration.

I'm including a few updated images (see Page 7) along with some very important comments made by former Lockheed Skunk Works president Ben Rich (see Page 6).

The general public has absolutely no idea what the true state of un-acknowledged special access programs are. Per Ben's comments to Jim Goodall: "**We have things that are 50 years beyond what you could possibly even dream of**". I should hope so, after spending upwards of 300 billion dollars per year on classified black programs!

UFO or A Secret Spy Plane?



The community of Great Gonerby, just west of Grantham, Lincolnshire, U.K., has been known as a small village with big numbers when it comes to UFO reports. Only recently, a series of UFO sightings has made newspaper headlines. The attention drawn to the village is primarily due to four years of continuous reports.

During that time, a strange object has been seen by many, including one Allan Spick. He saw it well enough to make a sketch. A copy of his depiction is included.

Another witness has come forward who asserts that he saw the same object over Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, Canada.

The anonymous witness said: "It was about 50 feet off the ground and not more than a city block away from me. I saw what appeared to be a craft that looked almost tear-shaped but sideways. I slowed down to a crawl and watched it hovering for about 10 seconds."



Another Similar Strange Hexagonal Craft Reported (1970's)


This report has been extracted from a general detailed report on UFO activity that occurred in the vicinity of the Marconi Space and Defence Establishment at Frimley, Surrey during the mid-70's.

It originates from Hilary Porter from Farnborough, Hampshire, Vice-Chairwoman of 'BEAMS' (British Earth and Aerial Mysteries Society), run by Hilary and her partner Ken Parsons.

Hilary has contributed many articles and reports to UFO organisations over the years and has appeared on a number of Television programmes describing her abduction and close contact experiences that occurred while she was working as a drawing office engineer for the Marconi Space and Defence Co.

The object (right) was described as:

"I remember looking out of my window, when I saw two orbs of bright light heading from West to East. One veered off towards Farnborough and the other took up a hovering position over the Frimley complex, before inexplicably extinguishing from view."



MYSTERIOUS LIGHT SCARES LOCAL WITNESSES IN DERBY



The above photo of a what appeared to be a glowing ball of light was captured by Richard Ratcliffe of Harvey Road, Derby on his mobile phone on the night of the 21st December 07. It was also observed by Mrs Ratcliffe and daughter Sonya. They were disturbed by the glowing light that traveled slowly, about 20' above the rooftops. It was seen three times during the night, at 10pm, 10.40pm and 11.40pm.

Although the object appeared to the witnesses as a glowing ball, the photograph shows that it was more of a crescent shape. There was no sound heard from the direction of the light and it does not appear to have been an aircraft/helicopter. It must remain unidentified at the present time.

Captured on camera (pictured above) in the Braid Hills area on Saturday night, these strange balls of light sparked notions of an alien landing somewhere in Morningside.

Several people reported sightings of the glowing objects between 8.50pm and 9pm. Student Lyle Brennan, 19, of Marchmont, was out walking in the hills with his friend Sam Mackay 20, when they saw the strange lights.

Mr Brennan said: "When we looked back over our shoulders we could see a succession of fiery orange lights moving across the sky. They appeared to be coming from the hills in groups of two or three, moving north very slowly and gradually burning out after about a minute." A number of other people had stopped to watch the lights when Mr Mackay took a brief video clip of them on his mobile phone. While no-one reported the sightings to the police, others have contacted the Evening News to ask what the strange lights were. Mr Brennan added: "We passed maybe five or six people who had stopped their cars and were looking at the lights. I thought at first they would be flares, but they seemed to move too slowly for that, and then just disappeared."

In 2007, a series of photographs of strange flying objects began surfacing on the Net. In time, these objects would come to be called the "drone" craft. In my article, [The Strange Craft Photographs](#), I stated that there had been many various explanations offered to explain these bizarre objects, but none of these were written in cement at that time.

More than a year later, although many have given the photos a "fake" stamp, I personally still have my doubts. It's not that I "want to believe," but I want to know the truth. I believe that it is possible that some of the drone photographs may be computer generated, but the question remains, "Are all of them hoaxes?" Could one or two copy cats have negated the validity of a couple of the objects that were actual craft? Now, there are a couple of private detectives on the case.



They have begun their inquiries by attempting to find the exact power pole that some of the Capitola, California, photographs were taken near. Private eyes Frankie Dixon, and T.K. Davis, are hot on the trail of the drones, and hope to put an end to the mystery of the photographs. Having seen and studied all of the photographs, it seems strange to me that if they had doubts of the authenticity of the images, they would put the time and effort in to prove that the strange, unknown objects could be the real thing. Now, keep in mind that if the photographs could be proven to be authentic, that would only prove that the object is real, and in no way give us any indication of its origin.


This first Australia UFO photo shows the strange but clearly seen triangle shape with what appears to be bright lights perched on each corner.

This Australia UFO photo was taken off Google Earth at a range of 10,571 ft., note the triangle with bright lights in the center.



A STRANGE STORY FROM WW2

We wondered if there was any substance behind stories of 'creatures' allegedly having been seen by RAF servicemen, accepting peoples understandable reluctance to report such matters. We finally came across someone who had the courage to tell what he saw. This was ex RAF Pilot/Navigator Sergeant William Davis (1805619), born 7-5-1923 and now a retired Head Teacher.

'Bill', now a resident of the Isle of Wight, but at the time based at Gimli RAF Airbase 18 SFTS (then a training base for the British Commonwealth Air Training Plan under the guidance of the Royal Canadian Air force from 194101871, now used by the Gimli Gliding Training centre and the Royal Canadian Air Cadets.) was to describe a bizarre incident while flying solo in an Anson V aircraft west of Lake Winnipegosis, on the night of the 10th of December 1944, close to the town of Brandon Canada. 'It was a clear moonlit night as I scanned the horizon, expecting the lights of Gimli Control Tower to come up, after having completed a two hours and 45minutes journey as part of my pilot's course to get my 'wings', having flown a triangular route from Gimli, on the shores of Lake Winnipeg, west to a town near the US border, then east to Brandon, before turning east towards the base at 130 mph. on a clear moonlit night with a thin blanket of snow covering the landscape below.

I checked my map and kept a good lookout, my eyes constantly sweeping the horizon from one side to the other and back, now and then checking the instruments, when I noticed what looked like two curious 'bumps', one either side of the nose of the aircraft, like tiny exhaust pipes, although the nose itself was empty. I decided to carry out a proper check when I landed and dismissed it from my mind. Suddenly, my eyes flashed back again to the nose. The 'Exhausts' had begun to move. They now looked like 'hands'. I thought this cannot be happening and checked to see if this wasn't some kind of reflection. Then a small entity resembling a pixie, or elf, the ones associated with folklore, appeared outside the aircraft, a few feet away from where I was sat. I thought this cannot be happening and pinched my thigh hard and tried to think what checks I could carry out inside the aircraft.



I will never forget its pinkish face - European in nature, with a thick short trimmed beard, close cut, covering its features, reminding me of an old English naval seaman dressed in some sort of green garb.. It was, approximately 18inches tall and apparently watching something in the sky to my left, moving slowly in a nonchalant manner, as if walking round the estate.

I was close enough to see. Instead of fingers he had what looked like little exhaust stubs, no thumbs, and pointed shoes made of velvet or some such material rather than leather. He began to stroll towards me, no more than 12-15 inches away, through the window, trying to attract his attention, but then realised when something appeared to catch his eye. By this time I was shouting and gesticulating to he was unlikely to hear me because of the sound of the aircraft engines. I had the impression he could not see me at all and was probably unaware of my existence. After about 30 seconds he sat down, looked below, and gave a slight lift with his hand at the side and pushed himself off the nose before disappearing from view. I continued on my way, not frightened but exhilarated by the experience.'

After landing, Bill mentioned out of interest to some of the ground Crew what he had seen but wasn't surprised when they burst out laughing. Feeling that reports of such nature could have prevented him from earning his 'Wings', he decided to keep quiet but was visited in his barracks, the next day, by the Senior Flying Instructor, who reassured him he hadn't been suffering from delusions, explaining he was not on his own, as other pilots had also reported having sighted what appears to have been the same small being,! The last word lies with Bill: 'It seemed so bloody real. I was not drinking or flying at a great height. I was fully awake and alert. I know what I saw and will never forget it.'

Mars Has Huge Ice Deposits

(Filers Files #12)

New York (PTI): Scientists claim to have found vast quantities of ice deposits below the surface across great swathes of Mars. Using data and images captured by the Sharad radar on NASA's Mars Reconnaissance Orbiter (MRO) spacecraft; they have discovered the frozen water in the Red Planet's mid-northern latitudes, far from its polar ice caps. According to the NASA scientists, the ice is found in distinctive geological structures on the Martian surface that are hundreds of meters thick. "We would say, robustly, more than 50 per cent ice by volume -- but it could be much more," Jeff Plaut, the Chief Scientist for Sharad, said.

In their analysis, the NASA team looked at Martian surface features called lobate debris aprons (LDAs) which are distinctive, dome-shaped structures concentrated in the Red Planet's northern and southern hemispheres. In fact, they concentrated at LDAs in the Deuteronilus Mensae region of Mars' northern hemisphere, where the features can be found at the bases of valley walls, craters and scarps of mesas.

Promethei Planum lies at 76° south and 105° east and is seasonally covered with a more than 3500 meter thick layer of ice in the Martian South Polar region. 2008



Writer Arthur C. Clarke Dead at Age of 90 (Wednesday March 19, 2008)


An innovative giant in the realm of science fiction, Sir Arthur C. Clarke, has died at the age of 90 in Sri Lanka. The English born Clarke will always be best known for his ground breaking film, "2001: A Space Odyssey." Clarke's collaboration with director Stanley Kubrick became a science fiction classic.

In his life, he wrote more than 80 fiction and non-fiction books, and was knighted for his work in literature. It never bothered Clarke that though his volume of work was immense, he was primarily remembered for his collaboration with Kubrick.

"It's better to be recognized for one thing, especially something of which I'm quite proud, than not to be recognized at all," Clarke told The L.A. Times in 1982. He won numerous international awards for his writing, and did write three sequels to "2001: A Space Odyssey."

He was a visionary, and foretold many technological breakthroughs, including the telecommunications satellite, which he invented. He was known as the "the godfather of the telecommunications satellite." (He served as an RAF Radar technician during WW2) *Source* [Billy Booth](#)
