## MOD - "UFO'S - WHAT UFO'S?"

It appears that the MOD are in a desperate rush to save costs by eliminating the necessity of logging numerous UFO reports (many of which are often LITS...Lights In The Sky).

They seem to be intent in ignoring what is going on in our skies and are no longer interested in accepting UFO reports and investigating them.

To date we have been frustrated in our efforts to find a government body that will accept the responsibility of logging ufo reports in the UK. Even though there is the possibility that they could represent an aerial threat to the UK or at the very least be of interest as unknown intruders.

While not subscribing to any conspiracy theory, there remains the possibility that there could well be a **'hidden agenda'** to the MOD actions. A letter from an associate in the UFO field, Dr. David Clarke is reproduced on the following page, also disclosing his frustration at the actions of the MOD.

We have been in communication with several military establishments, including the RAF HQ at High Wycombe and the RAF Northolt HQ, to find a solution to this problem, but so far to no avail!

In the following pages of this issue we will bring you up to date with some disturbing facts that we have discovered in recent weeks. These include images from our PRA 24/7 Derby sky camera, which has produced photographs of what appear to be triangular craft flying (or orbiting) at high altitude overhead.

## Comments from Dr. David Clarke:

13th February 2010

Hi Omar

Good to hear from you and yes, this is most interesting question.

I have a copy of a MoD notice issued to all military sources towards the end of last year drawing an end to their UFO reporting responsibility that dates back to the 1950s.

They are also asked not to encourage the public to report sightings to the military.

I'm trying to establish how this affects UFO reporting from sources that are not members of the public, which includes those from air traffic control and aircrews (civilian and military).

The changes appear to be mainly to stop members of the public reporting lights in the sky to the MoD which is costing them time and money to log and respond to.

As you will know they have been inundated with low-quality reports particularly during 2009 as a direct result of The Sun's campaign to turn every Chinese lantern into a alien invasion fleet.

This, in my view, is what has provided them with the opportunity to shut down the UFO desk.

As for the CAA. My understanding is CAA have a continuing responsibility to investigation "Mandatory Occurrence Reports" (MORs) and air-miss incidents, reported by aircrews.

They have no specific responsibility for "UFOs" per se, but if UFO incidents are reported as MORs or Air-misses - as in the recent case involving a police helicopter over Birmingham - these will be assessed in the usual way by a joint CAA-MoD working party.

I'm assuming this situation will continue after the closure of the MoD's UFO desk.

So I would suggest that any incidents reported by civilian air traffic controllers or aircrew should be reported to the CAA as MORs.

Other than CAA the only other official agency to whom the public could report UFO incidents would be the police. But the police (responsible to the Home Office) have no responsibility to investigate, log or analyse UFO reports made to them - unlike their French counterparts.

So unless you are aware that a particular incident has been reported to them, it's unlikely you will make any progress as police UFO reports tend to be destroyed quickly. Of course in the past, police had standard instructions to pass their reports to the MoD. But that policy has now been rescinded.

Not a very satisfactory situation, but I think this was inevitable. I hope this is of some use,

### 27 February 2010

*In response to a Freedom of Information Act request from myself and Joe McGonagle, MoD have released the documents that provide the background to the MoD decision, in November 2009, to close the UFO desk and "UFO Hotline". The 11-page document with 2 annexes was released free from redactions on 25 February. The most controversial revelation is that MoD intend to destroy all UFO reports - from whatever source - received after 30 November 2009 within 30 days of receipt to avoid any liability for FOI requests in future.*

## M.O.D. RELEASED REPORTS

Files released in February 2010

The files contain a wide range of UFO-related documents covering the years 1994-2000. They contain more about close encounters, strange illnesses, flying 'Toblerones' and unidentified objects tracked on radar.

Some 24 files of top secret sightings, letters and Parliamentary Questions have been released as part of a three-year project by the MoD and the National Archives.

They contain 6,000 pages of material spanning 1994 to 2000 and record hundreds of other-worldly experiences.

We have listed a few examples:

### **UFO 'was spotted above Michael Howard's home'** (Telegraph 18 February)

A large triangular UFO was seen hovering in the skies above former home secretary Michael Howard's home, according to Ministry of Defence files.

Eyewitnesses in Burmarsh and New Romney saw the "humming" object, the size of two passenger planes, near Mr Howard's home on March 8 1997, when he was serving as home secretary for the Conservative government.



Sophie Wadleigh, 25, from Hythe, reported the sighting to the Folkestone Herald. She told the newspaper: "It was so peculiar, it all felt really odd and I heard this humming noise. "As I looked across the field I saw a large **triangular shaped** flying craft hovering about 300 metres off the ground."

Ji Lane, 23 and Christopher Lee, 27, also witnessed the incident. Mr Lane said: "It was crazy - I was getting a drink in the kitchen when I saw these strange lights in the sky just over the field across the road from our house." Mr Lee added: "It was a lot longer than a plane and moved incredibly quickly - I have no idea what it was and we were both left speechless."

Further newspaper cuttings reveal Chris Rolfe, co-ordinator of group UFO Monitoring East Kent (UFOMEK), warned at the time the UFO could have been looking for Mr Howard. Mr Rolfe said: "It would seem the UFO was disinterested in Sophie, the girl who reported it and watched it for quite a long time. An eyewitness account in the UFOMEK report said: "It was just a **huge triangle** thing, which was a lot bigger than an aeroplane or anything like that. "It had lights all around the outside, and this disc attached to the back, and a big light on the front. I pulled up to a stop and as I did it shot off."

*ED: We welcome the observation and comments of Dr. David Clarke regarding this case, but we cannot agree that this could have been an aircraft or helicopter hovering near the house in question.*

*This is in view of our wide experience of logging and investigating the behaviour of 'Flying Triangle' craft since the late 80's.*

## MoD's records of UFO sightings a close encounter of the absurd kind (Alan Travis: Guardian UK)

Reports of flying Toblerones, close encounters of the second kind, and -attempted alien abductions in the latest batch of UFO files released today by the Ministry of Defence demonstrate that the British public's appetite for matters extraterrestrial shows no sign of abating. More than 650 reports of UFO sightings reached the MoD last year – the highest for 31 years – before it took the decision to close its UFO desk, known as Air Secretariat 2A1, in December.

The [latest files released at the National Archives](#) cover the period from 1994 to 2000 when sightings were running at 200 to 300 a year. The MoD intends to make public the files for the last 10 years by the end of 2011.


The files show that most reports are filed by "overzealous ufologists", and for the first time officials have released files based on reports from those they call "persistent correspondents". Foremost among these was the Alien Acknowledgement Campaign, which alleged an MoD cover-up of alien visitations. Its particular target was a freedom of information campaign to release the files on an incident in Rendlesham forest, Suffolk, in 1980 in which US and British [military](#) personnel testified that at least one UFO was tracked on

radar. The files show that it is not just dedicated ufologists who have shown an interest. Leading scientists, air traffic controllers, pilots and even Sir Winston Churchill have, too. The Churchill memorandum dates from 1952 when flying saucer speculation was at its peak as the dawning of the jet age fuelled science-fiction speculation in the public's imagination.

With figures as prominent as Lord Mountbatten willing to entertain the notion of extraterrestrial life, Churchill asked his air secretary, Lord Cherwell: "What does all this stuff about flying saucers amount to? Let me have a report at your convenience." Cherwell replied that the issue had been the subject of a full intelligence study in 1951: "The conclusions reached (based upon William of Occam's razor) were that all the incidents reported could be explained by one or other of the following causes: known astronomical or meteorological phenomena; mistaken identification of conventional aircraft, balloons, birds, etc; optical illusions and psychological delusions; deliberate hoaxes." Occam's razor is a principle for scientists that the simplest explanation tends to be the best.

The files include a letter from a retired senior MoD official, Ralph Noyes, who confirms that the "subject remained something of a joke (albeit an uneasy one on occasion)" in Whitehall in the 1950s. However he describes seeing gun camera film of [UFOs](#) taken by RAF fighter pilots in 1956 that was shown at a secret screening for air defence staff in 1970. A search of the archives in 1993-94 found no trace of these films.

ED: *I do not intend to fill the remaining pages with a selection taken from the MoD reports, as they may be seen on line. It is obvious from the general tone of the media that most of these reports are due to the actions of 'overzealous ufologists'. When will the media realise just what is going on? (see page 5).*



## ARE THERE AMERICAN AEROSPACE CRAFT IN EARTH ORBIT? What is going on in Space right now?

How much has the general public been told about the activities of mysterious craft reported to be orbiting the Earth? For a number of years we have seen video clips of mysterious lights approaching man's orbiting craft such as the MIR Space Station, the International Space Station and various Shuttle vehicles.

In recent months we have seen mysterious craft on the deep space video footage taken by the American researcher Ed Grimsley, using enhanced night viewing equipment (*see photo 1*). This has revealed what appears to be moving objects in space, criss-crossing each other and at times, what appear to be laser beams have been seen apparently fired from such craft.

There is something of a mysterious similarity to several photographs that have recently appeared on Utube and were purportedly taken over Dublin (apparently using identical equipment to Ed Grimsley). We are not aware that any Irish UFO groups are currently running such a surveillance system and there has generally been a feeling of pessimism over the lack of interest in the UFO subject. This only adds to speculation as to what is going on?

Meanwhile the battle to save computer hacker Gary McKinnon from extradition to the United States continues. The US is accusing Gary McKinnon the self-described 'bumbling computer nerd' from London of committing the biggest military computer hack of all time.

His prosecutors claim that in the course of a year the softly-spoken 40-year-old hacked into dozens of computers at NASA, the US Army, Navy, Air Force and Department of Defense

Obsessed with science fiction since childhood, he was convinced that the US was suppressing alien technology and evidence of UFOs and his study of the Disclosure Project ([www.disclosureproject.org](http://www.disclosureproject.org)), which includes 400 witness testimonies ranging from civilian air traffic control to people who were in charge of whether to use nuclear missiles.

**All of these people said there was anti gravity involved, which 'totally swung' it for Gary.**

One of those reports was from a photographic scientist for NASA, who worked at the Johnson Space Center and said they regularly airbrush UFO images from hi-res satellite imaging, so Gary went in and had a look. Scanning the networks was mostly very boring.

But then he found that what the photographic scientist had said was true: "There were folders called 'Processed' and 'Unprocessed'. "I managed to see three quarters of one and it looked like no manufacturing means I've ever seen in my life. It looked like an elongated satellite with domes above, below and to the left and to the right."

"No rivets, no seams, none of the usual signs of man-made machinery. But that's when the guy at the machines at NASA saw the mouse move. He right clicked the LAN icon and chose Disconnect – just when I found what I'd been after for two years!"

Gary also claimed to have discovered an unaccountable American organisation which he believes covertly lists personnel shown as 'Non-Terrestrial Officers'. Could they be involved in space travel? Are they in control of the craft now being photographed flying around our world at high altitude?



The fact that these mysterious craft exist, can be shown in the photographs below taken by our own PRA Sky camera, which video records the skies over Derby 24/7.

In the early hours of the 1st February, a delta shaped craft was tracked moving across the sky and past the waning full Moon . A 'still' from the video sequence is shown below together with an enlargement of the craft.

We have reason to believe that the United States are operating antigravity craft using technology developed by various U.S. military contractors as a result of reverse engineering captured extraterrestrial vehicles.

This information was initially disclosed by Col. Philip Corso, who was involved in the U.S. Army efforts to pass on extraterrestrial technologies to civilian industry. This was detailed in Col. Corso's book 'The Day After Roswell' (Pocket Books: ISBN: 0-671-00461-1 ).

While we believe that the 'Roswell' crash produced artefacts that enabled the U.S. to make many technical advances, there have been numerous UFO craft retrievals over past years. These have produced even more technical discoveries thus enabling the U.S. to make enormous strides in the field of extraterrestrial travel.

There has also been a great deal of speculation about the American TR3B (see right), a 'Black Budget' craft secretly developed by the U.S. This craft is believed to be using both atomic power /plasma drive and anti-gravity devices, which results in causing the craft to 'glow'.




We understand from various sources that a mass reduction unit operating in the craft has lowered the gravity down to 8% of normal .

There is great speculation that the TR3B is only one of several extraterrestrial craft being developed by the U.S. and goes under the name of the 'Astra'. Two other craft have been named as the 'Boomerang' and the 'Chameleon' (which is believed to be Hypersonic).

## Royal astronomer: 'Aliens may be staring us in the face'

Aliens may be “staring us in the face” in a form humans are unable to recognise, the Queen’s astronomer has said. [By Heidi Blake \(Telegraph\)](#) Published: 7:25AM GMT 22 Feb 2010



Lord Martin Rees, president of the [Royal Society](#) and astronomer to the Queen, said the existence of extra terrestrial life may be beyond human understanding.

He made the remarks shortly after hosting the national science academy’s first conference on the possibility of alien life.

“They could be staring us in the face and we just don’t recognise them. The problem is that we’re looking for something very much like us, assuming that they at least have something like the same mathematics and technology,” he said. “I suspect there could be life and intelligence out there in forms we can’t conceive. Just as a chimpanzee can’t understand quantum theory, it could be there as aspects of reality that are beyond the capacity of our brains.”

Lord Rees used the conference in January, entitled [The Detection of Extra-terrestrial Life and the Consequences for Science and Society](#), to ask whether the discovery of aliens would cause terror or delight on earth. He told [Prospect](#) magazine that improved telescopes made the chance of finding extra-terrestrial life “better than ever”.

But Dr Frank Drake, the world’s leading “ET hunter”, told the conference that satellite TV and the “digital revolution” was making humanity invisible to aliens by cutting the transmission of TV and radio signals into space. At present, the Earth is surrounded by a 50 light year-wide “shell” of radiation from analogue TV, radio and radar transmissions. But although the signals have spread far enough to reach many nearby star systems, they are rapidly vanishing in the wake of digital technology, according to Dr Drake.

**ED: *Regrettably the members of the Royal Society have their heads in the clouds (or should that be ‘in Space’). It reminds me of when my Jack Russell dog had run away while walking on a canal bank. I shouted across the water to someone on the other side, “Have you seen my dog” to which he replied “it’s there, under your nose”....which it was! Astronomers should come down to Earth and investigate the evidence of Alien contact here in their own backyard!***

## Multiple sightings of LITS over Shirebrook Notts. February 14th 2010



### Sighting over Shirebrook, Notts. February 12th 2010


## UFO seen in Phear Park, Exmouth

UFO sceptic Mr Shaw, of Withycombe Village Road, is the latest resident to report seeing strange coloured lights and says he spotted what he can only describe as a spaceship landing in Phear Park. The retired engineer and his dog ran for home when a white 'shimmering' shape began walking towards them. Roy Shaw does not believe in aliens, ghosts, flying saucers or anything he cannot physically touch or explain. But recently Mr Shaw, a retired engineer, saw something unusual in Phear Park that frightened him so much, it caused him to run home so fast he twisted his ankle in the process.

Mr Shaw said: "The object was round in shape and about 30-feet in diameter and 100-foot long, with blue and red flashing lights on its perimeter, and it appeared to land at the top end of the park by the bowling green. My dog started to growl when, what I can only describe as a white shape, came towards us." "It was about four-feet high and seemed to be translucent, and moved very slowly towards us."

"I was transfixed because it made a droning noise which sounded like 'my my,' over and over again, which I could not understand. "I didn't know where the sound was coming from but it was coming straight towards me. I immediately ran back down through the park."

Mr Shaw said the UFO appeared to hover over the hedge of the bowling green, then flew horizontally from left to right, before immediately shooting off at high speed, back to the left at a 45-degree angle. He said the UFO appeared from nowhere. He did not see it fly overhead, or land.

Mr Shaw said his normally-placid border collie dog, Sydney, ran away from the object after baring his teeth at the approaching figure. "I twisted my ankle when I ran like hell," said Mr Shaw. "My dog Syd kept whimpering and kept looking out of the bedroom window towards the park until at least two in the morning. "I had problems sleeping because I just kept going over in my mind what I had seen." "I still can't believe what I saw and I am still in a state of shock."

"Syd doesn't like going back up there now. Something put him off. Everybody thinks you are crank when you report something like this. I am an engineer. I like to touch and feel things. If I can touch it, it exists, but there's no way I can explain this."

Exmouth UFO expert Nigel Wright said: "This is a close encounter of the third kind."

"The definition of a third kind is having encountered an occupant of a UFO in close proximity to the craft itself." "This is a really important sighting."

## Learning to communicate with Extra Terrestrials – young children in India-China Himalayas use strange sign language

According to some teachers in the schools in that area, young children are extra agile and extra talented these days.


Their problem solving skills have increased and they are much more disciplined. They continually use a strange sign language among themselves. However they cannot teach this language to adults!

## South Carolina 'FT' UFO 18 December 2009



### GREENVILLE-SPARTANBURG INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (GSP) --

I saw bright lights just above the tree tops` at 5:40 PM, Friday, on December. 18, 2009, when I felt frightened because I thought a plane was going to crash. Then I could tell **how slow it was going** and its movement was level with the ground. I watched it move slowly just over the houses **without a sound**. Then it **stopped dead** and did not look like a plane. It just **hovered** over a house. A **white light shined down** like it was looking for something. I rolled down my window and knew it wasn't a helicopter, it had no blades and **no sound**. It looked flat on both sides and round in the middle when it was coming toward me. It looked like a rounded off triangle, fat near the middle and closed to the front.

It flew over me and I could see two large yellow stripes on the metallic. underside. It stopped and started to rotate as if to turn what I thought as the front toward me. **It made a swishing hydraulic sound** as it turned, it tilted up slightly.

It may have been rotating to move sideways straight ahead **very very slowly**. It was a solid craft, no wings or propellers. Two large red lights and a string of brilliant bright white small lights around the sides. I'm not sure if the small lights moved or its rotating made it look like they were flashing around the craft. I watched it stop over the retirement village. The area is on one of the GSP airport flight paths. It was going in the direction of the airport but very low and slow.

I was so close I could see **indentations or seams on the bottom**, maybe for landing gear? or how it was put together...

I see aircraft frequently but I don't know what this was. It stopped again, hovered, rotated and made no sound until it rotated. A plane or helicopter that was hovering that low would have blown out every window in these houses. It had **no vibrations**, and **no air movement**.

## MYSTERIOUS OBJECT CRASHES IN MONGOLIA—19th FEBRUARY 2010

There are scant details concerning this report other than the fact that the object crashed near the Mongolian capital city Ulaanbaatar and was estimated to weigh approx. 2 tons.



We covered bizarre cloud formations [before](#), but there seems to be no end of them... The tsunami-looking fog [wave](#) was strange enough, and now these "gateways in the sky" - circular absence of clouds, with wispy tendrils reaching out of them...



**Cloud Vortices: another "holey" sky phenomena**

Theodore von Karman's "Cloud Vortices" are something else, again: they form when the wind encounters a barrier - such as the Aleutian islands, in this case - and the flowing eddies of cloud create a weird pattern. The image you see below was photographed from the International Space Station, and the animation shows the double row of vortices, which rotate opposite from each other.

## TALE ENDERS

### MATLOCK AREA UFO. (DERBYSHIRE)

Hi, just thought I would share what I saw last night. (11th February 2010.)

I had just finished my tea and noticed an orange light in the sky outside. Thinking it was a really low plane I went to the garden for a look. There was no sound and it was flying about the same speed as a helicopter. It was a perfect round orange ball, illuminated from the inside and seemed to be following the A6 towards Matlock.

After some distance it stopped and went up through the cloud and out of sight. Whatever it was, it was not simply drifting in the wind it was flying quite in a perfectly straight line. *'Lotterythedog'*.

### MARCH 10, 1961; RAF UPPER HEYFORD, ENGLAND. UK. (BBU)(McDonald list)

At 9 p.m. local time, a very bright white or yellowish circular object was observed in

the sky at about a 45 degree angle and appeared to be stationary. All the observers indicate that the light/object was very bright. The object was also picked up on ground radar and the radar observer said the object was moving very slowly. The object was described as orange size to basketball size. The object was observed visually for approximately 10 minutes and observed on radar for approximately 20 minutes. There was no air traffic or known balloon release in the vicinity.

Among the observers were two Air policemen and a Control Tower Operator. (*Dan Wilson, Ohio, USA*)

### UFO LIGHTS SEEN OVER ALVASTON, DERBY. (Mid Jan 2010)

The witness is uncertain of the date, but it was on a Sunday in mid-January this year, probably Jan. 17th. At about 5pm, seen over Alvaston, Derby. The witness described that together with others, he had watched 6 red lights hovering at first and then going through a series of rapid manoeuvres, before shooting skyward and out of sight. The witness was adamant that the lights were not 'Chinese Lanterns'!

### QUEBEC CITY, CANADA; June 11, 1975

At 2100Z, a large Triangular shiny object was observed estimated to be above 40,000 feet over Quebec City, moving very slowly to the NNE. Object seen by a T-33 A/C at 29,000 feet and an DC-8 at 31,000 feet and also seen by personnel of Quebec Terminal. No contact by radar due to outages.
