UFO files reveal 'Rendlesham incident' papers missing

The disappearance came to light with the release of 8,000 previously classified documents on UFOs. Officials found a "huge" gap where defence intelligence files relating to the case should be, the papers show.

The incident took place near the fence of RAF Woodbridge Suffolk in 1980. - at that time being used by the US Air Force. A group of servicemen reported seeing strange lights in the trees near the base and after investigating found marks on the ground and damage to vegetation. **(ED: No mention of the encounter with the landed UFO craft then?)**

The files reveal the MoD received a request for its own records of the incident in 2000, but when officials looked they discovered a "huge" gap where defence intelligence files relating to it should be.

The hunt generated a series of notes, with one official speculating that the files could have been taken home by someone and another remarking that "it could be interpreted to mean that a deliberate attempt had been made to eradicate the records covering this incident".


However, among intelligence papers released in 2009, it was revealed that former Admiral of the Fleet Lord Hill-Norton wrote to the defence secretary about the incident in 1985, speculating that an unauthorised aircraft may have entered and left UK airspace at the time.

But it is not the only gap in the official record. In 2002 the MoD received a request for information from Lord Hill-Norton. He wanted to know about reports of a UFO sighting made by HMS Manchester while on exercise in the 1990s. It emerged in the file that HMS Manchester's log for one of the periods was lost overboard after "a gust of wind" and the vessel's captain cannot remember anything unusual taking place. **(ED: I served 7 years in RN. What a ridiculous explanation, this would have resulted in disciplinary action taken against the person concerned with keeping the log, a most important record).**

The files contain a trove of observations from British citizens about unexplained phenomena they observed in the sky and reported to the Ministry of Defence, including peculiarly flashing lights, oddly shaped or strangely behaving aircraft or things that just looked as if they did not belong there. There are also photographs and detailed diagrams of supposed alien spaceships that some U.F.O. spotters helpfully included with their letters.

There are government briefing papers; details of a House of Lords debate about U.F.O.'s in 1979; American documents prepared in the extraterrestrial-crazed 1950s; and a copy of a report produced in 1951 by the Flying Saucer Working Party, a Defence Ministry group convened to brief Prime Minister [Winston Churchill](#) on flying saucers.

In one letter from 1998, a man from West London wrote to announce that after observing a strange craft hovering over his garden, he awoke the next morning to find that he had undergone a period of unexplained time. Could he have been abducted and fallen into an alien space-time vacuum? No, an official wrote back: that was the night the clocks had been turned back an hour. *Continued over-*

Among the documents is testimony from an airline pilot and his son who say they spent five minutes watching an object made up of three circles fly past their garden in Hellingly, East Sussex. The pilot reported it to Air Traffic Control in West Drayton, and an official labelled his sighting as one by "a credible witness".

But another defence official later wrote a memo saying the report "contains nothing of air defence significance".

More attention is given to the crew of an RAF Tornado who encountered an object the size of a C130 Hercules transport aircraft while flying over the North Sea in 1990.

The pilot describes flying at Mach 0.8 but being overtaken by an aircraft the like of which he had never seen before.

He talks about lights and even "an engine area" but the files also show how a possible explanation emerges - a Russian rocket booster was re-entering the earth's atmosphere on that same night.

THE GREAT FLYING SAUCER HOAX

Another file released reveals six small "flying saucers" were found by members of the public in locations across southern England in 1967. Four police forces and the army were mobilised before it emerged the incident was a rag-day hoax by engineering students from Farnborough Technical College.

Six miniature saucers were found yesterday in fields on a 180 mile line between the Thames Estuary and the Bristol Channel. They were at intervals of about 30 miles.

They all appeared to be made of glass fibre, emitted a noise when moved and were the same size and weighed 50 lbs. And when two of the objects were opened, they were found to contain a foul smelling liquid like pigs swill. They also contained loud speakers, batteries and switching devices.

At first it was thought that the objects had been dropped from an aircraft, but by nightfall police concluded it was all an elaborate hoax.

Untold thousands of marine animals float dead in Amazon river & Florida





February 4, 2011 – **MATO GROSSO DO SUL/AMAZON** Region – At Aquidauana, pantanal region of the Mato Grosso do Sul state, shoals of painteds, pacus, golden fishes, cacharas – and even stingrays, are floating dead in Rio Negro, one of the largest in the Amazon River basin. The estimated Environmental Policy is of that several tons of fishes died, adding that the authorities and experts, they still do not have the scale of the ecological disaster. Biologist of the State Institute of the Environment, Robert Gill Machado, noted the phenomenon, considered of great proportion, after flying over the region of sub-basin of Rio Negro. At this place fishing is banned. The area is considered one of the nurseries of fish breeding of the Pantanal. According to the technicians of the Institute the symptoms that occur in this case are the same symptoms of other instances of the genre. The fish are dying putting their heads out of water trying to obtain air, due to lack of oxygen in the water. This deficiency is due to the large volume of ash produced by burned, which is carried by runoff along riverbeds of the wetland. However, the idea of blaming the ashes of forest burn has no rationale. The residents of the region, they don't believe in this theory. [-BWN](#)

Florida – SEBASTIAN, Fla. — Thousands of dead fish have washed up at Sebastian Inlet State Park according to WPBF u local user jhazel. Jhazel uploaded the photos Friday morning. In them, Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission officials said they believe a lack of oxygen is what killed the bait fish. “Just because there’s such a large school of them, they use up the oxygen really quickly, and because they are coming closer to shore, there’s not as high of a water turnover rate sometimes when you’re in an area with not as much tidal flow,” said Kelli O’Donnell with FWC. “I saw the fish jumping out there and I thought it was going to be a really good day for fishing, and then I noticed over here in the surf that they’re all dead,” fisherman Jeff Johnson told WPBF 25 News. FWC biologists arrived to assess the situation and take water samples as people watched. “It’s a little shocking, yes,” Johnson said. “I don’t know if there’s chemicals in the water or the temperatures that caused this.” - [MSNBC](#)

Californian fishermen and harbour chiefs were puzzled after millions of dead anchovies were found floating in a marina just south of Los Angeles on Tuesday. 12:22AM GMT 09 Mar 2011 Experts said the fish, found at a harbour in Redondo Beach, may have died from lack of oxygen due to algae, while locals wondered if high winds overnight might have something to do with it. Locals at Redondo Beach, where the stench from the dead fish hung over King Harbour, suggested that high winds could have driven the fish into the harbour, where their sheer numbers would have reduced the oxygen available. Experts were cautious. "What we're trying to tease apart is whether it's a consequence of algae build-up, a fish build-up or something toxic in the water," said David Caron of the University of southern California.

ANOTHER INVISIBLE UFO COMES TO LIGHT?

A photo recently submitted by a reader and taken around Dec 2010 at Felley Wood, Underwood.

It was taken by a friend of his daughter using a camera phone and didn't realise that the UFO was in the background.

ED: The strangeness of this incident is now becoming commonplace with the increased use of digital cameras and electronics to record a photographic image.

It seems likely that the UFO's caught on camera may be visible to the light spectrum of the camera and invisible to the narrow spectrum band of the human eye.

The spectrum of the human eye is limited and depends upon the wavelength of our optical range.

Readers will have noted the strange tubes of light that have appeared in photographs taken in a variety of locations ranging from a crowded office to a lonely area of countryside (OVNI Jan/Feb 2011 page 9).

The 'tubes' of light phenomenon show that the light appears to behave as though it is intelligently controlled and we may wonder if we are beginning to see a 'spirit in the form of a stream of light, once again invisible to the photographer at the time.


In a recent presentation to the PRA, Andrew Emmerson showed a series of slides taken near his home in Mansfield, Notts.

ANDOVER, A CENTRE OF UFO INTEREST

This fine painting by the late Dan Butcher (a SIGAP artist at the time), is shown above and was the result of the excellent depiction of a classic 'saucer' sketch originally drawn by Andover witness Miss J. Philpot, a school teacher under training at the time.

It was in the early hours (0415) of the morning of 27th September 1966, as Miss Philpot was in bed looking out of the window at the night sky, when she noticed a star-like object moving closer and closer. As it increased in size, she was able to see that it was "the shape of two soup plates, one on top of the other." It then moved off quickly and out of sight.

Andover, Hampshire has been the scene of numerous UFO sightings over the years, with the most recent sighting taking place at 8pm on the **27th February 2011**.

'Mary', one of several witnesses at the time described what she saw as a massive red light, below cloud cover and in the vicinity of 'TESCO'S' at Andover.

The light was observed for a period of some 20 minutes at first, when it moved slowly to the left, then reduced to a pinpoint of light, then returned to the right, appearing once again as a bright red light.

No noise was heard at the time and at the time of maximum brightness it was impossible to see any detail of the light source.

The total observation time including the time observed by the other witnesses was quite extensive.

A total of 1hr, 40mins.

'Mary' scanned the local Andover paper for any sign that other people had seen the light over the town, but there were no reports carried by the local media.

UFO incidents in the area of Andover, Basingstoke and Marlborough have been quite common over the years.

SOUTH YORKSHIRE UFO LIGHTS 12 JAN 2011

Dear Sir, I would like to share a relatively recent sighting my wife and I had. I was directed to your site after posting my experience on a UFO site that I came across while researching what we had seen.

I live in Barnsley, South Yorkshire, England.

On the evening of January 12th 2011 at 5:45p.m (dark) My wife, 12 month old son and I were driving home. We'd just picked our son up from my mother's house in Darfield. My wife was driving and I was looking out of the windscreen and passenger window. As we drove down the A6195 toward the first Park Spring roundabout I saw a horizontal line of light in the sky, I made a joking comment to my wife "look at that, it looks like a tie-fighter from star wars" I made this remark as there were two noticeably brighter lights on each end of the line of light, which at first gave the impression that it was an H shape due to the glare of the bright lights on either side through the glass. the width of the line of light was about a finger-tip length (I know this isn't accurate as fingertips vary but it's what I used to remember at the time, so we're talking about little less than an inch, roughly.)

As we entered the roundabout and took the first exit onto Park Spring Road (A6195) I continued to watch and asked my wife "Seriously, what is that", to which she replied that she had no idea, it was probably a plane and that she was trying to concentrate on driving. Not satisfied I asked her to pull over at the next roundabout on the Park Spring Road. The first exit off of the roundabout I asked her to stop at is a little dead end with a small tin-sheet building near it. Upon getting out of the car I kept watching it and observed that the line of lights was a minty green colour, like white and green but sort of mixed and that the two brighter, distinct lights on either end were white, though there was no gap between the green glow and the white lights.

The line was still and did not move, the lights were also still, no blinking or anything. As my eyes became accustomed to looking at the light against the clear night sky I could clearly make out that the line of lights made up one side of a dark triangle.

Despite it being night time, the shape became clearer against the night sky as my eyes settled. I could hear a noise like an aeroplane but when I later questioned my wife about the whole incident she said that there was an aeroplane that she observed that had passed overhead going toward Doncaster, so in other words it was in the opposite direction to the object I was looking at that she saw out of her driver-side window. As my son was in the car I decided it best to head home and for me to come back out on my own with the binoculars and camcorder so I jumped back in the car and we carried on, though fairly hastily.

As we continued down the A6195 I noticed three crisp bright white lights about 1.5 inches above the tree-line, due to the bendy road this appeared to move position but as we got closer it appeared to be above the new school that is being built off of the roundabout where Collier Road meets Pontefract Road. Two of the lights were horizontal and were on the same level and the third light was above the two other lights but closer to the bottom light on the right hand side, giving the impression that this was in a triangle formation.

Though due to there just being 3 lights with no distinguishable/visible object or frame connecting them it was not possible for me to determine whether it was an actual triangle object or just one light above two others. Plus we were looking at it head on/slightly to our right and did not have the opportunity to see it from any other angle in order to gauge the depth/shape of it from other angles.

There is a crane on the school site, but only the cab is illuminated (when it is illuminated it is a solid rectangle with red lighting as it was this evening). The three lights we saw were visibly well above the horizontal crane and hence were a lot higher than the flood lighting on the building site. As we got closer again I was asking my wife what she thought it was and whether she could see it. She could, though again was unable to pay as much attention due to driving. As we got closer we could see the lights pulsating/fading off, on, off, on, they were pulsating in synch with each other but were gradually getting dimmer each time they came back. it was like watching lights behind a shimmering heatwave or as if cloud or fog was quickly whiping over them and as they got dimmer they went out one by one.

It was a clear night and the lights were not high enough to be at cloud level. At this point I was really frustrated and worked up and just wanted to get home so that I could come out with the camcorder and binoculars. There was nowhere to safely pull over due to other cars and so the best I could do was look back out of the side window but the lights had gone by the time we actually passed where they were.

I continued to look in the direction of the lights as we continued our journey. After taking the 3rd exit on the roundabout where Collier Road meets Pontefract Road onto the A628 I was looking back in the general direction through my wife's passenger window and saw an orange round pulsating light about the size of a pea which was moving very quickly toward our direction. I commented to my wife that it was moving towards us very quickly.

It was pulsing on and off consistently, half as fast as the three white lights I'd seen shortly before. As we left the A628 and drove along the High street I could still see the orange light and watched as the orange light turned into a vertical spike of bright white lights (about 5) They were not so distinct that I could count them but I could tell from the glare that they were individual sources but were so close it looked like a single spike.

They were not pulsating and still moving towards Shafton. The spike of lights then changed into 4 distinct bright pulsating white lights in a neat/proper square formation the spike of lights and lights in a square formation were the size of pin-heads and were very bright. They were pulsating at the same rate as the orange round light. I observed the 4 lights in square formation move parallel to Shafton high-street albeit set back and about 2 inches above roof level and move off in the direction of New Lodge. We eventually made it home and I frantically got our camcorder and my binoculars and went back out. I drove back to the site where we had pulled over and got out and looked around, feeling rather stupid as there were loads of people driving by watching me staring up into the sky. I didn't see anything else but have been keeping an eye out since. I have no idea if the things I saw above were linked to each other but feel that they were in some way which is why I've kept the info regarding the none-triangular formations in here. I did notice a man on the high street looking up at the orange light and presumably saw it change into a spike of white lights and the four lights in square formation, though due to rushing home I could not ask.

It's worth noting that there were workmen working on the new school site as we drove past and saw the three lights. Whether or not anyone else saw what we did I'm not sure, but would imagine someone on the site must have, especially if on the elevated framework of the building. I haven't had the guts to go and ask them for fear of sounding stupid or being told that they don't have time to talk to me. It sounds silly, but the thought of sounding stupid has really put me off investigating this further and given that it was back in January it's even more off-putting because I've left it so long.

Please contact me should you wish to discuss. As you probably gathered, my real name is not Waltsy (it was the name I picked when I posted my sighting notes on said UFO site/forum, however I would like to remain anonymous. As mentioned above public ridicule is not something that appeals to me so do not want any personal details popping up anywhere.


MIDLANDS UFO REPORTS ON THE INCREASE

Doncaster -- I was in the garden with my daughter on February 26, 2011, at 8 PM, facing south and found it odd that there was just one little cloud right above our heads. It was about the size of my hand at arm's length. I looked back at the cloud to see a cluster of 30 to 40 small star like lights with a hint of blue to them that dropped straight down from the sky. The lights formed a boomerang shape about 15 inches across at arm's length at about 1000 feet altitude. It started moving east very slowly and had no visible outline like it was camouflaged to match the sky. I only saw it because it cloaked the sky as it moved.

Historic First: A Spacecraft Orbits Mercury

March 18, 2011: NASA's MESSENGER spacecraft successfully achieved orbit around Mercury at approximately 9 p.m. EDT on Thursday, March 17. This marks the first time a spacecraft has accomplished this engineering and scientific milestone at our solar system's innermost planet.

"This mission will continue to revolutionize our understanding of Mercury during the coming year," said NASA Administrator Charles Bolden, who was at MESSENGER mission control at the Johns Hopkins University Applied Physics Laboratory in Laurel, Md., as engineers received telemetry data confirming orbit insertion. "NASA science is rewriting text books. MESSENGER is a great example of how our scientists are innovating to push the envelope of human knowledge."



At 9:10 p.m. EDT, engineers Operations Center, received the anticipated radiometric signals confirming nominal burn shutdown and successful insertion of the MESSENGER probe into orbit around the planet Mercury. NASA's MERcury SURFACE, SPACE ENvironment, GEochemistry, and RANGING, or MESSENGER, rotated back to the Earth by 9:45 p.m. EDT, and started transmitting data. Upon review of the data, the engineering and operations teams confirmed the burn executed nominally with all subsystems reporting a clean burn and no logged errors.

MESSENGER's main thruster fired for approximately 15 minutes at 8:45 p.m., slowing the spacecraft by 1,929 miles per hour and easing it into the planned orbit about Mercury. The rendezvous took place about 96 million miles from Earth. "Achieving Mercury orbit was by far the biggest milestone since MESSENGER was launched more than six and a half years ago," said Peter Bedini, MESSENGER project manager of the Applied Physics Laboratory (APL). "This accomplishment is the fruit of a tremendous amount of labor on the part of the navigation, guidance-and-control, and mission operations teams, who shepherded the spacecraft through its 4.9-billion-mile journey."

For the next several weeks, APL engineers will be focused on ensuring the spacecraft's systems are all working well in Mercury's harsh thermal environment. Starting on March 23, the instruments will be turned on and checked out, and on April 4 the mission's primary science phase will begin.

"Despite its proximity to Earth, the planet Mercury has for decades been comparatively unexplored," said Sean Solomon, MESSENGER principal investigator of the Carnegie Institution of Washington. "For the first time in history, a scientific observatory is in orbit about our solar system's innermost planet. Mercury's secrets, and the implications they hold for the formation and evolution of Earth-like planets, are about to be revealed."

APL designed and built the spacecraft. The lab manages and operates the mission for NASA's Science Mission Directorate in Washington.

ANOTHER UFO CASE FROM THE MOD FILES

Barnes (London)-- Paul Teed writes, "A star gazer was left so terrified when a UFO flew over his garden he contacted the Ministry of Defence in October, 1998. The shaken man believed he may have had a close encounter with aliens when a -- cigar-shaped vehicle suddenly appeared over his house. He told defense officials the mysterious craft had a white light -- flashing round and round underneath. His sighting was one of thousands revealed last week when the National Archives released previously classified documents.

The man said, "I went downstairs at about 12.15 am to get a glass of milk and sat on his garden bench and heard a distant roar' of engines getting louder. Suddenly a huge craft' appeared over the house, heading west that was a large cigar shaped vehicle with big projectiles on each side like wings. It had two very bright lights at the front and a white light flashing around underneath. I think there were also colored lights at the ends of the projectiles but I'm not certain - I was too bloody terrified

He saw a line of lights (which I took to be windows) along the side. It disappeared into the distance getting closer to the ground. The MOD said it did not have the resources to investigate his sighting, but believed it could have been a Sky ship 600 airship.

An official said: -- Unless there is evidence of a potential threat to the United Kingdom from an external military source, and to date no UFO' report has revealed such evidence, we do not attempt to identify the precise nature of each sighting reported to us.

However, the released MOD documents showed how the possibility of aliens has been discussed at the highest levels of Government, even featuring in a House of Lords debate in 1979.

VOICES FROM SPACE

Through the ages, men and women have claimed to have heard voices calling to them, but in the late 50s Fredrich Jurgenson, a Russian-born Swedish film producer, writer, and one time opera singer, by chance made the first actual tape-recordings of these

voices from space, and brought this strange phenomenon to the attention of parapsychologists.

Leading experts in electronics, physics and psychology investigated Jurgenson's research, and were unable to find any physical explanation. Jurgenson wrote two

books dealing with his discovery, and its implications. As a result of reading Jurgenson's work, the Latvian psychologist, Dr Konstantin Raudive, then living in Germany, went to Sweden to study Jurgenson's claims. He was soon convinced of the reality of

the phenomenon, and later set up his own research project. As a result of this research Dr Raudive published his own findings in a book entitled *The Inaudible Becomes Audible*. Later, this work was much enlarged, covering the study of 72,000 voice recordings, and published under the apt title *Breakthrough*. British and American research into the voice phenomenon or EVP (Electronic Voice Phenomenon), as it is known, is therefore based upon the techniques advocated by Dr Raudive.

These differ in some respects to Jurgenson's, although both men were convinced that the voices recorded were those of the dead. Jurgenson was decorated by Pope Paul VI with the Commanders Cross of the Order of St Gregory the Great in 1969, and there is no doubt that the Vatican gave a sympathetic ear to Jurgenson's research into EVP. Professor Dr Hans Bender, perhaps the world's leading parapsychologist, has been in touch with Jurgenson since 1964, and has investigated his work with exploratory experiments. As a result, Professor Bender stated: 'demonstration of the paranormal origin of certain recordings is extremely probable.'

Tests of Dr Raudive's recording methods were carried out in England, by the firm of Belling & Lee, who are used to test sophisticated, electronic defence equipment. These tests were supervised by electronic expert and physicist, Peter Hale, and Ralph Lovelock. The laboratory's equipment was set up and factory-fresh tapes used. Tests were made in a Faraday cage—a special compartment designed to keep out radio and electromagnetic waves.

Only a few minutes into the tests, there was visual evidence on the recording meters that some energy was coming through. On playback some 200 voices could be heard. Peter Hale said: 'In view of

the tests carried out in a screened laboratory in my firm, I cannot account for or explain what happened in normal physical terms.'

Voices can be recorded by several methods, one using microphone alone. One is aware that at times various items of electrical equipment can pick up radio signals, and it has even been suggested that radio programmes may be picked up in parts, weeks after transmission. Although when using the radio mike technique it is, I believe, possible to record radio intrusions in part and mistake these for EVP, such errors are rare and do not account for the genuine paranormal voice recordings.

Possible origins

There are, therefore, three possibilities for the origin of the voices: They are the voices of the dead; they are the voices of some extraterrestrial beings from space; they are a product of the experimenter's own unconscious projected somehow, possibly via PK, onto the magnetic tape. This latter concept is preferred by many psychologists and is finding increasing support.

But the idea that the unconscious should turn to electronics to make conscious material that has no emotional explosive content seems, to me, psychologically unsound. Certainly, it fails to account for the male and female voices that are recorded with their own frequencies, the polyglot speech, not to mention the content of the recordings. In assuming that the voices manifest by psychokinesis, no regard has been made to the physiological condition of subjects using PK, based upon Soviet research (indicating stress). My own research, using GSR test equipment, into experimenters indicates the opposite physiological state—relaxation.

If the voices are those of the dead, then the hypothesis of 'central state materialism' is proven false, as indeed is the 'mind-body' theory. But, if the voices come from some other life form, this would tie in with other phenomena, such as UFOs, and perhaps explain the peculiarities of speech recorded. We must not lose sight of the possibility that more than one explanation is feasible, for science recognises the possible existence not only of other dimensions, a parallel universe, but of anti-matter and anti-worlds.

Jurgenson, Raudive and other researchers believed that the voices were those of the dead, as claimed, and I admit that this is the explanation that my own research favours. How the voices manifest on tape we do not know and, if they are the voices of the dead, one might well ask how spiritual beings without vocal organs can speak. Yet the idea of full-blown survival, in which our body is duplicated by an etheric body, is held to be a possibility by some Spiritualists, and was the expressed view of Arthur Findlay who felt that communication takes place the same way as it does in life (*On the Edge of the Etheric*).

Professor Alex Schneider, however, has pointed out that some of the voices sound as if they were constructed from the homogeneous noise spectrum, by some unknown physical process. In 1976/7 I experimented using 'noise' as a source and, using the vibrations from this, voices were able to manifest; the first sentence recorded by this method stated: 'We are here.' It would appear reasonable, therefore, to suggest that some 'modulation' of sound, audio or electromagnetic, takes place.

Voices are also able to come through on radio using the transmitted signal, wiping out the

original broadcast for a few seconds and replacing it with their own communication, as if a more powerful transmitter was beamed at us from space. These radio intrusions have been mostly noted on medium wave, in the region of 1445/50 KHz. Most of Jurgenson's and Raudive's voice recordings were made on medium wave, but other researchers have experimented on other frequencies. I have made successful recordings on short wave, but experiments with VHF proved disappointing.

I have been able to make recordings not only from my home base, but also from hundreds of miles away, and now frequently make microphone recordings on a battery operated portable cassette-recorder when in the countryside, walking and driving. But I have found that there must be a certain 'noise source' in order for voices to manifest. Microphone voices are weaker than those obtained by the radio mike method, and sentences shorter. In the radio mike and inter-frequency methods I have found extended dialogue to be possible; this is two-way communication, the most advanced form of contact known, and can last up to 20 minutes.

It is reported that a major recording company will shortly release the extended dialogue recordings made by Jurgenson, which feature voices of great clarity and could be heard without the usual need to replay. When this happens, one can expect great new surge of interest in this field of research. In spite of the fact that the electronic voices were first studied 20 years ago, scientists have failed to offer any adequate

physical explanation.

There appears to be a widespread and general lack of information, even among parapsychologists, in this research. Often, when I mention this work to someone familiar with electronics, he will suggest tests that were made in the 60s, and for years science has claimed its inability to seriously consider paranormal phenomena because experiments could not be repeated under laboratory conditions.

Now, such conditions can be met, we have a method of 'communication' that uses electronics rather than the human medium. A tape-recorder has no unconscious and records all signals, normal or paranormal, fed into it. True, I believe that the mind of the researcher forges the link between the unseen entities and ourselves but, in other respects, the communication is direct, and not filtered through the impressions, conscious or unconscious, of a 'mental medium'. The criticism that is directed at the banal quality of the content of the average messages of mediums is not reflected in the EVP recordings of dialogue, although some of the odd words that are at times recorded do appear out of context. But there is a tendency to receive messages that are symbolically expressed which can be understood at a later date, and some voices also display an ability to predict future happenings.

I could easily fill a book with recordings that I have made, but I doubt if many would believe them genuine, unless they had heard them for themselves. But I would like to point out that all my statements can be supported by the taped evidence, and examples of

my voice recordings have been heard by Professor Dr Hans Bender of the University of Freiburg, who also commented upon their clarity.

These voices will address me by name, sometimes identify themselves, and discuss matters relating to my own questions. They display peculiarities of speech, often coming across at a very fast rate of delivery, and have a peculiar pitch and sing-song rhythm. Sometimes sentences are composed of words in different languages (polyglot), often sentence construction is clipped to a telegram-style and laws of grammar ignored.

These are not radio intrusions from earthly transmitters, radio scraps picked up, as the use of my name proves. I am aware from my recordings that the voice entities can hear us, can also see us, even in the closest detail. The recognition of these facts is, to say the least, amazing, and quite beyond the belief of our conventional understanding of what is and is not possible.

Indeed, were these recordings not made on tape, which others are therefore able to confirm, we might have begun to doubt our own sanity and might well ponder whether all the voices heard by 'schizophrenics' were indeed imagination!

Researchers from all round the world have made millions of recordings of these voices and, in West Germany alone, there are reported to be some 300 engaged in this work. The idea that some giant hoax is being foisted upon the public is quite ridiculous considering the many years of research by noted scientists, and the vast number of recordings made.

A breakthrough to another dimension has been made, a door previously closed opened. Our understanding of the nature of man and the universe can never be the same as it was before.
