# UFO DETECTION!

## By Nigel Brockwell



This is a very difficult subject to investigate, electronically and cheaply. My experience of UFO's is limited to just one brief sighting. This sighting was a good many years ago, back in my early twenties (1970s). I would like to share my experience with you, before I start this subject of UFO detection.

At that time I lived in a house near Bedford, England. I wasn't able to sleep that night and it must have been about 2 am, or so. I decided to open the curtains and spend some time looking outside. I remember not seeing any stars out, in fact, only complete high-level cloud cover. Suddenly a small defused white light came into view and travelling across the sky at an incredible speed, too fast for a conventional aircraft. The light seemed to be on its own, no other coloured changes or flashing lights, and not a sound could be heard.

I know what you are thinking, how could he have enough experience to write an article on the detection of UFO's! Well, all I can say is, I will try to give you some ideas on the type of electronic equipment we could use, to monitor the possible visitation of a UFO.

I have made a short list, from the many eye witness reports about UFO's.

- 1) **Bright lights, coloured, constant and pulsing.**
- 2) **Sounds - silent, roar, explosion, hum, buzzing, whoosh, swish, shrill, whistle, beeps and pulses.**
- 3) **Speed - very fast with great movability.**
- 4) **Magnetic - to generate or effect a magnetic field.**
- 5) **Radiation - generating high levels of microwaves.**
- 6) **Temperatures - changes observed in close proximity.**
- 7) **Electrical - electronically operated equipment failure.**
- 8) **Smell.**

From the above list I will go through each one and explain what electronic equipment could be used, and how it might be set up to detect a UFO.

### **Bright lights, coloured, constant and pulsing.**

Firstly, let's look at bright lights, regardless of their colour. We need to find a way of detecting just a moving light. Again, we will leave out its speed and being mistaken for an aircraft for

the moment. The basic detection of a moving and not a stationary changing intensity light overhead can be done simply by using two sensors. Those two sensors could be an LDR (light dependant resistor) type, connected to a circuit that monitors the light level from both of these sensors at the same time. A lens is placed in front of the two sensors, at their focal point, working a bit like the human eye. While light falls on both sensors equally, no alarm will sound. In a situation where a moving light moves overhead and above the two



focused sensors, an imbalance occurs on the sensors causing an alarm to sound. If the two sensors are set up correctly, it should be immune to any lights switching on and off nearby, even lightning.

I've used a similar detector to look for light or dark shadows moving in a haunted location. Left is a picture of my Brotronics "Shadow Movement Detector".

The simple moving light detector should be able to detect coloured, and flashing lights moving over the sensors. Detecting a very fast speeding object is a little more difficult and would be down to the sensitivity of the detecting circuitry. Using a more complex circuit it could be possible to filter out aircraft's known flashing beacons, as these flash at a set frequency. The down side to any UFO detection system is the location, whether you live in or near a town that's emitting large amounts of light pollution. You might also live near high rise buildings or trees, minimizing the field of view.


**QUESTION** - could lights on a UFO be emitting in the infra-red or ultraviolet spectrum which is not seen by humans?

**ANSWER** - I believe they do, a lot of UFO movies have sprung up on "YouTube" where people have been using night vision scopes. One particular movie shows lights arranged in the shape of a "V". (See right)



On the next page is a block diagram of the simple moving light detector.


This is a quick description of the detectors operation and set up.



Light falling on the lens is focused onto the two light sensing detectors. An electronic circuit converts the resistance from the two (LDR) sensors to a voltage. The output voltage from

the two sensors is compared and any imbalance detected triggers the alarm sounder.

A voltage change is also sent to a pen recorder or computer data logging system. The moving light detector would ideally need to be set up in an open space, with a maximum view of the sky. The positions of the two sensors is a matter of choice, but if you've been lucky enough to have spotted UFO's on many occasions and their direction is known, then just place the sensors in line with their flight path. (See right)



## 2) Sounds - silent, roar, explosion, hum, buzzing, whoosh, swish, shrill, whistle, beeps and pulses.



A specific UFO sound is an area not easily tackled, because we live in a world of diverse sounds. Most reported UFO's seem to be void of any sound altogether. Should our alien friends like to communicate in ultrasound or infrasound, then we have a chance of picking something up. I feel quite confident in saying that UFO's do generate some ultrasound and or infrasound from their spacecraft's.

Infrasound is quite difficult to monitor and these detectors don't come cheap either. At Brotronics I have a Detector that will pick up infrasound, but it also picks up audible sounds as well. Ultrasonic detection is so much easier to do, with two different types of detection to choose from. Firstly, a wide band system could be used which will monitor all ultrasonic frequencies at the same time. This would mean of course, a specific ultrasonic frequency could not be noted for future reference. Secondly, a tunable ultrasonic detector could be used, allowing us to note down the exact frequency detected, but we might miss something altogether, if we were to stop on just one frequency! Guessing the sound a UFO might make, with the hope of detecting it, is not my idea of sound science. Detecting known audible frequencies and setting off an alarm is of course quite feasible, but what frequency do we choose? Left is a picture of my "Brotronics Ultrasonic Receiver".

## 3) Speed - very fast with great movability.

Very little can be done here, electrically, unless the UFO travels at great speed, for example, going faster than the speed of sound and producing the typical sonic bang, which could be detected, even audible!

**QUESTION** - Why don't we hear reports of sonic bangs, as

UFO's accelerate away to near light speeds?

**ANSWER** - It might be because of the UFO's shape, or because the UFO accelerates so quickly, that it's through the speed of sound in such a short time.


## 4) Magnetic - to generate or effect a magnetic field.

Monitoring changes in a magnetic field is perhaps the easiest thing to do with electronics. For the Paranormal Investigator we have a wide choice of EMF (electro magnetic field) detectors, to look for changes at haunted locations. When detecting UFO's, should we use electro magnetic or magnetic? Personally, I would expect the changes to be more towards magnetic.

One particular detector used by many people in paranormal research, is the TriField EM Meter, this can also be used to detect magnetic UFO signatures. See picture of the "TriField EM Meter" right.

Why would UFO's generate or affect the magnetic fields? Unfortunately, I'm not qualified in this area to give you an answer. Again, I can only add that perhaps their engine has some sort of effect, either generating or affecting the earth's magnetic field, around its own space. To detect these magnetic changes we can use one of two methods.

The first uses a mechanical / electronic system, which basically uses a compass needle to interrupt a light beam. At Brotronics, I experimented with a modified compass for paranormal work. See the two diagrams below.



Using the compass method means it has to be set to magnetic north. Once set, any change in the magnetic field around the compass causes its pointer to move. As the pointer moves, its interruption with an infrared light beam causes changing voltage to be sent to the light level detector. When the correct adjusted level has been reached, an alarm will sound. Information can also be sent to a pen recorder or computer data logger, for later analysis.

The second method uses a largely wound coil, which might consist of a thousand or more turns of wire on a former. This type of detection system would greatly improve set up time and wouldn't require level ground, unlike the compass. But, which method is best? Personally, I would go for the coil method, if only to eliminate the mechanical parts, which are prone to outside influences such as vibrations.

This method of detection needs very little description or setting up. The large coil picks up the change in magnetism and this signal is fed to an amplifier and converted into a voltage. One part controls the alarm sounder and the other is sent to a pen recorder or computer data logger, for later analysis.

If you require hearing a changing audible (frequency) tone that varies with a corresponding magnetic level, then this can be done by simply adding a V.C.O. (voltage controlled oscillator) circuit, so a changing voltage will produce a changing audible tone. Further to this, you might want to add a moving coil meter, or even a digital multi-meter. Setting up this magnetic detector is straight forward; simply place in an open space, away from buildings. When the correct adjusted level has been reached, an alarm will sound. Information can also be sent to a pen recorder or computer data logger, for later analysis, as before.

**QUESTION** - Would an aircraft passing overhead trigger either of these two methods?

**ANSWER** - An airplane would need to fly extremely low to effect them. Reports seem to show that UFO's flying fairly high up influence the magnetic field, so much so, that electrical and electronic appliance's can be effected.

### 5) Radiation - generating high levels of microwaves.

Radiation is usually detected after reports of a UFO flying low or landing. Radiation is something we don't wish to get very close to, which could result in some form of skin burns, rashes or even cancer. Radiation monitors would allow us to keep a safe distance from the monitoring station, in the unlikely event of a UFO landing next to you! Equipment is available, ready made or in kit form, or you might want to purchase an ex-military (these don't detect microwaves) type. For those living in the UK, you might want to check the Internet for ex-military equipment.

### 6) Temperatures - changes observed in close proximity.

Temperature changes are something I wasn't aware of, until just recently. Perhaps, the UFO stimulates the air around it by its propulsion system generating heat, or just certain parts of a UFO rotate causing friction with the air, this of course would generate heat. If this is the case, then we will need to monitor temperature. Probably one of the lowest priced air flow meters, and used by Brotronics paranormal investigations, is the "Tecpel DTM 305B" See the picture below.

Again, we might like to use an audible changing (frequency) tone, detecting temperature changes. The same V.C.O. from the magnetic detector could be used here, to convert a voltage to frequency.

### 7) Electrical - electronically operated equipment failure.

Equipment failure is something we can't do very much about, if it happens! Our monitoring station could literary shut down. Radios, car navigation equipment or even Television interference have all been reported. How is this possible?

There is very little we can do to monitor this type of power failure, when it's just about everything that's affected. A simple battery operated mains power failure alarm could prove useful, in this

### 8) Smell.

The idea that UFOs might produce some unique odours originally carried a touch of humour. But they really do! An early survey of some UFO literature turned up 18 cases where witnesses noticed peculiar odours and attempted to describe them. Comparisons with Sulphur dioxide, as in rotten eggs, were the most numerous. Other descriptions referred to benzene and its derivatives. Finally, a number of descriptions almost certainly identified ozone. We have no way to monitor smells with the use of electronics; it's down to your nose and the honesty of your close friends!

### The conclusion!

Just as in the detection of ghostly activity, we have to use every piece of electronic equipment we possibly can, in the hope of catching something unusual! I would say, do the same for UFO detection, you can never have enough equipment.

I used to be extremely interested in the UFO subject, but it lost some of its flair, waiting ages for my next sighting. In autumn, 2007, I took my family out for a Sunday lunch, to a public house more noted for its ghostly night activity. I had my Olympus camera with me and started taking a few pictures after the meal. Some of the pictures were taken inside and some out. On one of the pictures showing the public house roof, I later observed a white spot on it. Is it a UFO or just a bird? Have a look at the picture, right.

I will let you decide. The object appeared to be stationary! All I can add is that this public house lies in an area of Bedfordshire known for its many UFO sightings!

After talking about UFO's going through the speed of sound, I came across a picture of an F/A-18 flying at transonic speed. Has anybody taken a UFO picture that looks like this?



I have only touched on the edge of UFO Detection, which is down to experience and cost! Computer Data Logging Software could prove very useful for recording, light levels, sound, vibration, magnetic and temperature information. If you are interested in the detection of UFO's and have some knowledge of electronic circuits, then this should not pose much of a challenge.

# UFO's Over Loch Ness

You know there is more than one mystery at Loch Ness! Over the years many people have reported seeing UFOs above Loch Ness and in this article I'd like to bring a few of them to your attention.

Firstly I'd like to bring you my own UFO sighting at Loch Ness but firstly I'd just like to inform you about my own interest in "Nessie" and my own 'possible' sighting of the creature itself!

## Malcolm Robinson's 'Nessie' and UFO sighting!

It was 1968 and I was 11 years of age. My family always took summer holidays throughout the British Isles and this particular summer we had decided to travel north and visit Loch Ness. I still remember my father filling my head with stories of this famous 'beastie' and wondering if it were true. Being young, I wasn't aware (as I am now) of the vast amount of literature regarding "Nessie" and these stories my father were listened to and digested with amazement by my young and ever enquiring mind. My father finished his stories by saying, "Now listen son, don't forget to look out for "Nessie" when we are up there, for you never know if you might see her or not" Well I was well and truly primed, and I recall talking about nothing else for days prior to this trip, I'm sure my friends must have been sick of the sight of me for they knew that all I would talk about was my upcoming trip to Loch Ness. It wasn't long before summer came round and the family car was heading northwards towards Inverness. As I gazed out of the car window on that long hot drive to Inverness I pondered as to how all my friends did not share this deep fascination that I had for all things 'weird and wonderful'. To them, subjects like UFOs, ghosts and poltergeists and now the Loch Ness Monster were subjects to be laughed at and not to be seriously addressed. "Why oh why" I thought to myself did the public not put too much importance on these subjects.

These subjects appeared to be the endless butt of jokes and rid-

icule, through not only the television and cinema, but more so through newspapers, (I had avidly been collecting reports from the Scottish press of all things strange and weird).

The miles were quickly eaten away and it wasn't long before the family car entered an Inverness camp and caravan park. That night I could hardly sleep for thinking about the following day's trip to Loch Ness. Little did I realise it then but this trip would prove to be one of the biggest influences in my life in regards to finding out one way or the other what exactly was (or was not !) in Loch Ness.

The day arrived, and a glorious hot summer's day it was too. My father had booked the family onto one of the few pleasure boats that regularly took holiday makers up and down the loch.



My younger brother Robert and I walked all around this boat more times than I care to remember. Whilst on the boat, Robert my brother kept asking me for a loan of our father's binoculars that hung around my neck. His request however, fell on deaf ears; for there was no way that I was going to part with these priceless binoculars, for these binoculars were going to enable me to see "Nessie" or so I thought.

So here I was, standing on board this pleasure cruiser looking at the vastness of Loch Ness. Loch Ness stretches for around 24 miles and is the largest body of freshwater in the British Isles and has had a monster reputation ever since St Columba visited the loch in AD565, where, as accounts would have it, he scared off the water 'beastie' by commanding it to leave as it was pursuing a lone and no doubt scared swimmer. Whether this account is actually true or not is open to debate! As I stood on the deck of this boat I honestly felt it awe of this place. To the left and to the right of me were steep sloping hillsides which fell sharply into the loch. As I stood gazing down into the Loch the feelings that I was getting were indescribable. I was totally captivated by this place; it was everything that was ever said about it. My father's binoculars were

continually raised to my eyes as I scanned the loch in expectant hopes of a sighting. "Wouldn't it be great," I thought to myself, "If I actually saw the Loch Ness Monster"!

Well the words were no longer thought of when my gaze through the binoculars was fastened on a large dark humped shape in the water. I remember becoming most excited about this and I was convinced that what I was looking at 'was' the Loch Ness Monster and nobody was going to tell me any different. I viewed this object for some seconds, I can't remember exactly how long before it slowly descended into the murky peat stained depths of the loch. Had I really seen the fabled Loch Ness Monster or had my primed and perhaps over active expectant imagination taken hold of me! I quickly ran to the back of the boat where my parents were sitting and excitedly told them what I saw.

Needless to say I was met with smiles and was told that I had probably seen some water fowl on the loch diving down. It all sounds fairly reasonable to me now but that moment on Loch Ness will live with me forever. All I know for sure is that I saw 'something' and that 'something' was enough to produce in me a sense of purpose, more so for the future. I knew that I had to return to this place, I knew that I would have to speak to those people who claimed to have witnessed "Nessie". I knew that I would have to conduct my own loch side vigils, and as General Douglas MacArthur famously said, "I will return". I had caught the fever, the fever of Loch Ness and I knew it would never go away. And although there are a number of other loch and lake 'monster' sightings from around the world when one visits Loch Ness, more so for this first time, the mystique of the loch is such that upon seeing it, feeling it, one cannot fail to be impressed and captivated by its mystery, (whether you believe in its alleged mysterious in-

habitants or not!).

I have visited Loch Ness many times since then and indeed in 1994 I was fortunate enough to go down in a small submarine and visit the depths of Loch Ness, that experience alone was truly superb. Being confined in this small submersible with trickles of condensation running down it's inside walls and looking out through a number of small viewing port-holes is something that I will equally never forget. And no, I didn't see "Nessie" on that trip! As a matter of fact, did you know that according to experts (!) you could get the entire population of the world in Loch Ness, not once, but three times over! That gives you an idea as to the sheer size and depth of the



place.

So that was my early introduction to Loch Ness, a place that I have now visited many times, but getting back to the main point, that of my UFO sighting at Loch Ness. It was 1982 I was up at Loch Ness with my wife Rose who at this point in time was now well accustomed to my Investigative travelling work. I termed this a 'working holiday' whilst she preferred just to call it a holiday. For me this was yet another great opportunity to meet and interview people who lived and worked along the loch side in regards to their own observations of "Nessie". It had been quite a tiring day and having completed my interviews it was time to retire back to our base which was the camping and caravan site at Invermoriston on the shores of the loch. After a

quick wash and change, my wife and I went out for a stroll down by the loch side where we happened to come upon a party of tourists who were all sharing a camp fire on the shores of the loch. We asked if we could join them and with a resounding "by all means", sat down. I remember there were an American couple there and also some English tourists as well. We soon struck up a conversation which needless to say centred around "Nessie" herself, before we knew it, it was around 11:50pm. I remember the night so well, it was a lovely cool evening with a fantastic dark sky peppered with the multitude of heavenly stars in every direction. Someone threw some logs back onto the camp fire and the discussion continued. Listening to what was being said I gazed across the loch and looked at the dark silhouette of the hills on the opposite side of the loch. The conversation was interrupted by an American woman who was facing me (I had my back to the loch) who shouted out, "What the hell is that"! I looked at her surprised face and followed her pointed finger in the direction which pointed to the silhouetted hills

on the other side of the loch. I watched what I can only describe as a half circle or a 'dome shaped light' which was moving up and down behind the hill at the opposite side of the loch. This was a bright white light which was pulsating. By now everyone in the party was a gasp at this strange spectacle.

Now I knew that at this particular spot there were not any houses or roads in which perhaps one could surmise that if it was a car heading up an incline, then perhaps the car headlights may reflect of low lying cloud. This I knew was not the case. Firstly because there were no roads at this spot and secondly the sky was devoid of any cloud for this effect to have been accomplished. The object continued to bob up and down behind the hill when all of a sudden it completely

stopped above the hill, then with a tremendous burst of speed, vanished off into the heavens and was gone in seconds. Silence prevailed, everyone knew that we had witnessed something spectacular and out of the ordinary. I've since learned that there have been a number of UFO sightings at Loch Ness over the years. In point of fact a year or so before this UFO sighting, I was again up at Loch Ness interviewing witnesses and also a chap called Frank Searle. Frank had left his home in England



and travelled up to Loch Ness to devote a good part of his life by trying to 'prove' the 'monster's existence. All he did however, was to create suspicion when numerous photographs that he claimed he took of "Nessie" in clear sharp focus, were the subject of much scrutiny and debate. Some even went so far as to say that the 'creature' captured in Frank's photographs closely resembled the image of a dinosaur which could be found on a postcard for sale in a souvenir shop in Inverness. One of my main questions to Frank that day was in regards to his remarkable daylight photograph of a UFO as it swooped over Loch Ness and was published in the Scottish Daily Record newspaper. However I soon learned that Frank was none too keen to speak about that photograph and quickly said that if I didn't stick to the "Nessie" questions he would terminate the interview! Well needless to say I didn't continue with the UFO question, I had travelled many miles to see him and I wasn't going to through the baby out with the bathwater at the final hurdle, although admittedly when I completed my interview with him I 'did' ask him about this photograph, he still wouldn't tell me. Frank mysteriously left Loch Ness in suspicious circumstances, a model "Nessie" was found under a boulder at his camp site although admittedly that could have been left by anyone, as far as I know, no one has seen hide nor hare of Frank Searle at Loch Ness since then.

Another person that has seen a UFO at Loch Ness, is "Nessie" researcher William Jobes. Here is what he had to tell me in a recent e-mail (April 2016)

Dear Malcolm,

It was good to speak with you again. As promised I've attempted to write about an incident I witnessed many years ago at Loch Ness.

During the summer of 1971 when I was 22 years old I spent the week of 7th - 14th August at Achnahannet, the camp site of The Loch Ness Investigation Bureau (LNIB). On the 13th, my final evening with the team, about 15 of us visited a local hotel in Drumnadrochit to attend a film show by Tim Dinsdale. Mr Dinsdale showed us the footage of his movie capturing a sighting of an animate object which he was convinced was the famous Nessie.

When we arrived back at the Achnahannet camp site around 11.30pm we noticed a large bright light on the opposite side of the loch. The light seemed to travel towards the middle of the loch where it then appeared as a large round sphere as if a huge full moon. It had a blue halo and although it appeared transparent it had a multitude of colours radiating from its core and this lit up the surface of the loch in all directions for as far as we could see. The UFO stayed in what appeared a stationary position for about 30 seconds then completely vanished. It was a clear summer night and not pitch black but the change in the light when the UFO vanished was dramatic. We all looked at each other in disbelief and wondered what we had just witnessed.

Immediately Tim Dinsdale advised us all not to discuss this incident with anyone especially the press. The reason for this was the previous week the press had ridiculed the LNIB for being asleep when the workers from the Aluminium smelter plant at Lower Foyers had watched the head, neck and humps of a creature travelling up the middle of the Loch, past the LNIB camp site heading north, during their early morning tea break.

Some of the people to witness this incident were ;

(Me) William Jobes, Tim Dinsdale, Wendy Dinsdale, Alexandra Dinsdale, Holly Arnold, Dick Raynor, Phillipa Hammond, Mary Nay, Robert (Brock) Badger, Christine Hunter, Rip Hepple, Jeff Hepple, Robert Cuthill, Angela Richards, Nick Meades, and Jonathan Chanon.

To this day I don't know if anyone ever reported this sighting. Hope this is of interest to you.




# Messiah's Of The New Age By Brian Allan



## Forward

If there is one thing that the subject of belief in the existence of extra-terrestrial spacecraft visiting the planet earth has in common with religion, it is the vital element of unquestioning faith.

Faith; it cannot be overstated just how vital this no quantifiable and intangible factor is to the existence of both. Neither can be conclusively proven and neither can be totally disproven, but in spite of this both con-



tinue to exist.

In the case of the three main monotheistic faiths, Judaism, Christianity and Islam, they have at most been existence for, at most, approximately 3000 years. In planetary terms and in terms of the existence of the human race, this is less than the blink of an eye, yet to date they still exist, although to some extent the influence of Christianity is slowly waning. In the case of the UFO phenomenon, in spite of abundant evidence that the entire edifice is fundamentally flawed, it, perversely, also clings grimly to life, its embers still fanned into sporadic life by a procession of sincere apologists and well intentioned diehards.

All that gives hope to the faithful is the off chance that their 'holy grail' will appear in the form of either still classified but indisputable government documents or the landing of a craft in the full glare of public scrutiny. Until either of these two events occurs then it, like religion, must remain an item of faith. Any-

one who doubts this should attend a religious service and a UFO conference, the same rapt expressions can often be found on the faces of both audiences. Other common factors shared by the two subjects are the prophets and messiahs that speak for both beliefs and it is to this similarity that we now turn our attention.

## Messiahs of the New Age

Something odd has happened to the convoluted and frequently ephemeral world of hard core Ufology with all its highly detailed and well publicised encounters, including the iconic alleged landings and sightings at Socorro, Roswell and Gulf Breeze in the USA, Shag Harbour in Canada, Rendlesham and Bonnybridge in the UK plus myriad others world wide. They have all gradually faded into oblivion to be replaced with, well, what exactly? Why are there almost no intriguing and often terrifying accounts of abduction by alien intruders, of downed and retrieved extra-terrestrial spacecraft?

Where are the new reports of the visits and covert and frequently overt threats made by the sinister, apparently non-human, 'Men in Black' to those who witnessed UFO's in flight: and cattle mutilations, what about them? What was the final verdict surrounding the fate of untold numbers of unfortunate farm animals that fell victim to inhuman and barbaric treatment by parties unknown? The reason for this may be that the bait has been laid and taken and the trap sprung, but let's begin by looking at these few strands of the UFO mythos more closely because these are only the most high profile facets and like most complex subjects the closer one looks, like fractal images, the more complex it becomes. There is further likelihood involving the intelligence agencies and their perceived need to cultivate and manipulate the UFO belief system for its own ends, but in this setting that is best left for another time.

One of the most influential and best known alien abduction

guru's was the New York sculptor and artist, the late Budd Hopkins, who compiled many apparently convincing accounts of such abductions via the frequently disputed technique of hypnotic regression. One of most notable of these was Linda Cortile, whose version of events, it should be noted, has subsequently and justifiably been called into question due to the lack of verifiable independent corroboration. Another offshoot of Ufology, cattle mutilations, created an entire sub-genre in its own right complete with its own adherents and prophets, chief among them Linda Moulton-Howe, who travelled widely investigating many reported cases and to her credit did not flinch from getting up close and personal with the decaying and frequently putrid carcasses. It also has to be said that she wrote and spoke with great sincerity in support of this particular aspect of the phenomenon.



Although there were many bizarre features associated with the alleged mutilations, including uncannily accurate clinical and apparently cauterised incisions, plus the total exsanguination of many carcasses etc., etc. The main culprits, in the absence of any other obviously guilty party, were always assumed to be an amalgam of alien/government/military chicanery, or a cover-up designed to test a range of weapons. At its most extreme it was even mooted that extra-terrestrials of reptilian appearance, (reptoids), were carrying out the mutilations to recover the blood for sustenance, this practise evidently included many human victims. However, it has since been persuasively demonstrated that given the right conditions nature can provide apparent 'wounds' identical to those supposedly caused by unnatural interference. Now, over time, even this particularly grisly branch of the UFO universe has faded from view; so what has gone wrong?

The answer to this has to be the UFOlogical equivalent of a flat calm; the almost irresistible storm of excitement that highlighted and propelled accounts from the 20th century has blown itself out, unless the odd sightings of lights in the sky, (LITS), count as worthwhile evidence of extra-terrestrial encounters, which in all honesty they do not. In fact, taken worldwide, 'The Great UFO Flap' has effectively ceased to exist and all we have left are continual retellings and reinterpretations of the cases and incidents that did actually amount to something. While it lasted it provided a source of entertainment and interest for swathes of the population worldwide and also created a market for hundreds of books on the subject. Initially, some were sen-

sationalist and exploitative nonsense designed for the gullible and curious, but later came others that were much more rational, reasoned and thoughtful, arguing the pros and cons of the subject in measured terms.

It was also a source of income for many good and genuine people like, among others, Stanton Friedman, Darrel Sims, Jenny Randles, Timothy Good, Nick Redfern and Nick Pope, who became hailed as experts on various aspects of the subject and undertook, and indeed still undertake, speaking engagements addressing conventions and conferences of like minded people around the world. Friedman, for example, is renowned for his well argued and staunch support for the Roswell crash landings and the consequent appearance of the MJ12 documents apparently naming a

committee of well known military and political figures tasked with managing any contact with ET's. Sims on the other hand is acknowledged for his views on alien implants, the small, subcutaneous artefacts occasionally found on alleged abductees. Since it purports to present examples of alien technology it is perhaps one of the most hotly debated aspects of the entire phenomenon. Jenny Randles, one of the most effective investigators still actively involved in this field of research, although accepting UFOs as part of her remit investigates all aspects of the paranormal. Redfern, Good and Pope all still lecture and write extensively and almost exclusively about the subject.

In every case, although their hypotheses can, as already noted, neither be conclusively proved nor disproved, these sincere individuals have in effect become the evangelists of a belief system that although weakened refused to die and in its diminished state tried to evolve into something else. Because of this and depending on how one perceives it, we can see how the entire subject can take on an entirely different perspective: that of a new spirituality and substitute for religion, for if one thinks about it all the necessary requirements are already there. This is not too unlikely either, consider that there are, even now, organisations word-wide, particularly in the fundamentalist sections of the Christian faith, who openly state that UFO's are the instruments of Satan and the occupants are Satan's messengers sent to the Earth to confound and confuse humanity: they are 'The Powers of Principalities of the Air and Those that Fly'

## The Prophets and Visionaries

While these proponents of Ufology perform the function of evangelists, what about the originators of modern Ufology, in effect 'the church elders'? While there is no doubt that large numbers of sincere people did experience events for which they have no rational explanation, equally there is no doubt that in the early days the subject was also hijacked for their own ends by many liars, frauds and charlatans and of course the merely deluded. Having said that there have been some truly remarkable and colourful characters, particularly in the 1950's, and 60's, namely the self proclaimed contactees like 'Professor' George Adamski (1891-1965), 'Dr' George King (1919-1997), George Van Tassel (1910-1978), Earnest and Ruth Norman (1904-1971 & 1900-1993 respectively) and Eduard Albert (Billy) Meier (1937- ) to name but a few and all claim unexpected and involuntary telepathic contact by their mentors, the so called 'Space People' of various types.

Of this small group, perhaps George Adamski, Ruth and Ernest Norman, George Van Tassel, and George King attained a spurious kind of lasting fame, although for different reasons. Indeed, 'The Aetherius Society', founded by former taxi driver, George King, and 'The Unarians' along with the 'Unarius Academy of Science' both founded by Ruth and Ernest Norman, still exist today in a number of locations around the world. It goes without saying that the 'science' disseminated and promoted by both of these bodies is not that practised in any conventional sense. Instead of science it had the feel of a new spirituality and religion,

a means of salvation and was probably, along with the Findhorn Community in Scotland, another UFO/nature spirit based concept, one of the first manifestation of New Age thinking and philosophy.

Meier's claim to fame came, once again, in the form of telepathic contact with extra-terrestrials from the Pleiades and as result of this contact took many pictures of their spacecraft, the supposed 'Plaedian Beam ships'. In particular he alleges direct contact with the occupants, chiefly with one female named 'Semjase' who conveyed a series of environmental warnings. It is slightly worrying that the name of the female being, Semjase, is remarkably similar to that of one of the fallen angels, Semjaza, and given their supposed point of origin the two beings may even share a common identity and purpose. Semjase arrives to warn mankind against its self-destructive urges while Semjaza taught humanity about 'roots and enchantments'. Whether this is accidental or deliberate is a moot point, so in truth 'Billy' Meier was, and continues to be, something of an enigma.

It is curious that overtly flamboyant characters like Ruth Norman, who, incidentally, claimed that she was the reincarnation of, amongst others, Queen Elizabeth the 1st, Socrates and Mary of Bethany, all share a propensity to dress in a rather extravagant fashion. In Ruth Norman's case she was given to wearing fairy like ball gowns, tiaras and holding 'magic wands'. In addition to this she was also effectively an Avatar since she claimed to be the incarnation of the Archangel Uriel. It was perhaps

rather unfortunate that her habit of driving around the streets in her hometown with a large model UFO attached to the roof of her car caused the neighbours to dub her, 'Spaceship Ruthie'.

Similarly, the goal of George King's Aetherius Society is also apparently peaceful and they seek to charge specific mountains with positive energy derived from meditation and prayer via device of Kings own devising under instruction from the 'Masters'. This power is intended for release in times of great tribulation to benefit the planet. The device was once actually shown in the late 1960's on British TV in a programme devoted to the Aetherius Society. The viewers were allowed to see the majority of the artefact, a fairly long device with a box at one end, but King did not allow one section to be viewed, as this was evidently secret and not for profane eyes. George King did in fact appear live on television actually channelling messages from the 'Cosmic Masters'; which necessitated wearing dark glasses and speaking in a gruff and over pronounced manner and I was fortunate enough to see both the device and the channelling session when the programme was transmitted.

Another of the American contactees, George Van Tassel, who, in a subterranean chamber below the huge rock that gave its name to the location, supposedly channelled a series of ET entities including, 'Knut' and 'Ashtar', an entity that has lasted the course fairly well as the 'Ashtar Command'. He actually succeeded in creating a kind of open-air convention centre in the Mojave Desert called the 'Giant Rock Spacecraft Convention'. The location was frequented by some of personalities mentioned above who gave informal lectures to the UFO faithful. He went on to found the 'College of Universal Wisdom', and was also favoured, like many of the others, with a trip on board one of his 'friends' spacecraft.

Van Tassels crowning achievement was the construction of a domed, white, wooden, building called 'The Integration', fashioned using no metal fastenings. It was designed to specifications relayed to him by his 'friends', and was intended to rejuvenate the physiology of those who entered. It was also claimed to act as a type of dimensional projector that could display images from different eras within its interior. When he died in 1978 his legacy largely died with him, but the Integration still remains and still is viewable by appointment. Before leaving this character it is interesting to note that the Integratron bore certain similarities to 'The Goetheaneum', a spectacular and organically beautiful art deco construction designed and built by the philosopher and mystic Rudolph Steiner.

With a few notable exceptions it is fair to say that in the main they were sincere if misguided in their beliefs, unfortunately, in the case of George Adamski, who, for reasons of increasing his credibility elevated his position as a hamburger seller to that of a professor, there is abundant evidence to suggest that his account was little more than a cynical money making ploy. It is probably significant that during the era of prohibition in the USA he instituted a centre for spiritual learning and development that required sacramental wine.

Under the strictures of this legislation he was allowed, like all faiths that used alcohol in their sacraments, to manufacture the wine in large quantities, needless to say the majority of it managed to find its way, at a profit, into the local community although not for sacramental purposes. It has been recorded that Adamski viewed the end of the prohibition era with some regret, causing him to reflect that, if it had not ended, he would, quote, 'Not have had to get into this saucer crap'. One thing that is slightly disturbing is the fact that even today people who should know better still persist in validating Adamski's claims.

Another trait shared by some of the aforementioned luminaries was a fondness for grandiose titles including bogus doctorates both secular and non-secular, dubious professorships, minor royalty, (George King eventually assumed the title of 'Count'), and in the case of Ernest Norman, a former incarnation as none of the than Jesus of Nazareth. Although in retrospect none of them did anything worthwhile for serious Ufology, at least they raised public awareness of the subject and it is regrettable that almost all of these characters are now no longer with us, though they would probably have argued that in some form they still are, and we are all the poorer for it

### New Religion?

What these particular individuals actually created were substitute religions based on a series of channelled, mostly altruistic messages and instructions received from a hierarchy of Ascended Masters, Cosmic Masters, The Council of Nine and of course the ever reliable Space Brothers, because to all intents and purposes they shared many of the same precepts as conventional religious belief systems. The difference comes in terms of sheer accessibility and immediacy. According to George King's Aetherius Society, Jesus Christ, along with Buddha, Krishna and other deities, is an ascended master rather in the style of Madam Helena Blavatski's '*Theosophical Society*', with whose tenets they shared a number of similarities.







when America and the then USSR threatened the entire world with their incompatible ideologies. The Christian and Jewish God was in some way either too fierce or too intangible to deal with the multitude of fears and anxieties that arose, which of course created a vacuum, it was a vacuum that Ufology was able to fill because it presented real hope. It is not difficult to see why these cult-like organisations gained a following; the attraction was obvious and very accessible, especially when the leader of the group was able to convey comforting messages directly from any particular member of the spiritual hierarchy to which they subscribed.



Within the body of dedicated UFO cultists, as with any organisation or belief system that functions almost entirely on faith alone, there are schisms and factions protesting that theirs is the only truth, when in fact they all may have fragments of a greater truth. Instead of Catholic and Protestant, Jew or Gentile, Muslim or Infidel we have believers in the various strands of extra-terrestrial belief; e.g. the extra-terrestrial hypothesis, (ETH) and the psychosocial hypothesis, (PSH) leavened with offshoots into underground bases, shape changers and an entire zoo of ET species, Greys, Nordics, Reptoids and everything in between. This is where faith holds sway, for as with religion, in every case other than hearsay and circumstantial evidence, there is not one single shred of corroborating material to substantiate any of it.

It is evident then that Ufology might just fulfil a universal need in that it can be everything to everyone, equally there is evi-

dence that the whole subject of UFO's and Ufology can be likened to an analogy of the bible, the messiah and salvation, only in this case, as has already been said, it was much more believable and accessible to the masses. As we have already seen it had its prophets and preachers, apostles and acolytes, angels and demons and even divine intervention in the shape of giant spacecraft designated to carry off the faithful to a paradise in the cosmos. In fact it resonates with the teachings of fundamentalist millennial groups who advocated 'The Rapture', when the Christian faithful would be physically and literally carried away, lifted from the surface of the planet to their just reward in heaven.



So far these groups have been relatively well intentioned and mild, if eccentric, but a few have been positively lethal; Marshall Herf Applewhite and the 'Heavens Gate' cult is a case in point and perhaps best serves to encapsulate and demonstrate the very worst aspects of these doctrines.

Heavens Gate seems to have been composed of an unstable leader and an equally unstable flock of social inadequate, in effect poor lost souls who were convinced that the Hale-Bop comet concealed a spacecraft in its tail. All the adherents of Applewhite's crazed philosophy had to do was commit suicide, which would allow them to access a state that was, according to their leader, 'above human', after which they could enter the concealed spacecraft and be transported to some far distant cosmic nirvana and sadly, the vast majority did, including the demented Applewhite.

In its most recent manifestation, *faux*-religious UFO belief surfaced as 'The Raelians', who are quite specific about their function and the extra-terrestrial origins of the human race and have managed to attract a good sized following. The founder, Rael, a former French racing driver, has established himself as a truly messianic figure whose function is as a prophet/intermediary between his flock and the Space People. Other

than constructing a large mock flying saucer and founding 'Clonaid', an organisation devoted to research into human cloning with a view to providing the service for profit and on demand. The ethics of this notwithstanding, the Raelians have done little to differentiate themselves from all those who have gone before and depend on the charisma of their leader making them almost a personality cult.

This brings us back almost to the full circle, why are these groups and organisations needed and why do they almost universally receive support. This is probably due in part to the nature of the human condition. No one is an island and in some individuals this manifests in inadequacy, a lack of security, uncertainty and loneliness, the previously mentioned 'lost souls', and all of these deficiencies are fulfilled by saucer cults and quasi-religions. It is also fair to suggest that the people subscribing to the teaching and paradigms of saucer based groups are equally likely to fall prey to other organisations espousing similar unconventional ideas, but not necessarily saucer based.

If the landings and sightings were indeed the bait, then, as we have seen it was eagerly taken and the trap successfully sprung, so perhaps there is no longer a need for overt displays of 'saucer power', because to some the reality of a Cosmic Messiah has been demonstrated. But as long as there is doubt then groups like these will fulfil a need and supply ready answers. However, providing they are not harmful or destructive then they do no real harm and perhaps even serve a useful sociological purpose. However, like the age-old question regarding the existence of God, whether or not extra-terrestrials and a Cosmic Messiah actually exist falls into exactly the same grey area and the proof for either relies entirely on faith alone

As a final comment on what we have seen here: the problem with the beliefs espoused by the 'true believers' discussed here in whatever their system of belief happens to be, is that for them their ideas can never be satisfactorily disproved or shown to be false, simply because anyone who does produce valid and irrefutable evidence, be it scientist or academic, that undermines their belief, automatically causes the 'plot' to expand to include the person providing the conflicting evidence.

In other words irrespective of how good the evidence is, it must be a lie designed to undermine them and whoever provides the information becomes en-

meshed in the plot. This is what drives and provides rationale to many of those espousing the outer limits of belief. However, the other side of the coin suggests that society has only itself to blame through the inequalities that have polarised it and allowed distrust and disillusionment to grow. This, in turn, provided fertile ground upon which to sow many of the more bizarre ideas around today. They succeed simply because they supply certainty in troubled times.

# The Medium Experiment!

Over the last two to three years researching Bempton and the surrounding area I have thought and tried many things in an effort to get answers as to why so many unusual things seem to be happening around this location. The people who had vanished, the lightforms, UFOs and everything in-between. Flashpoints that occurred in dramatic fashion then imploded just as quickly leaving nothing. I noted that at times these same locations seemed able to affect a person's mood. But What could influence mood to such a degree that it could make a person feel ill or worse. I had been indirectly told about this during my research. But I wanted to test it, to see these phenomena at work first hand to see if an area or something within it could affect mood. My first attempts involved me taking people to a place I called Dark Wood at Danes Dyke. I told them nothing and just observed, I wanted the essence of dark wood to affect them the way it had made me feel. It did not disappoint but it still fell short of anything other than my crazy ramblings. To take this further I needed a spiritual medium, if there was any truth in the theory someone in tune with this vast outer nowhere would be able to detect it.

### THE MEDIUMS

On the 20.5.16 I invited two spiritual mediums to come with me and Andi Ramsden on a visit to Danes Dyke woods and if time allowed a short visit to Bempton cliffs afterwards. At the point of offering the invitation all the spiritual mediums knew was that I had an interest in the unexplained. They were new to the area, so had no prior knowledge of any of the events that had taken place at the locations I would be taking them. The pair was mother and son Janet aged 52 and her son Karl aged 30. We first became acquainted due to a chance meeting that my good friend Andi Ramsden had with them a few weeks before. It was ironic that I had recently been discussing the possibilities of using mediums as another way to gain knowledge and further insight into the phenomena surrounding UFOs and other events in locations of high strangeness. And suddenly this set of circumstances presented itself.

I don't know what to call it but I knew after Andi told me about his chance meeting with a lady who was a spiritual medium that I had to get her opinion on the areas we are investigating. Little did I know at that point that the medium would turn out to be the lady who had just moved into the house over the road from ours? The words it's a small world spring to mind. I knew something about a small finger of woodland at Danes Dyke that I call Dark Wood was different to the surrounding parts it connected to, that and the area surrounding RAF Bempton.

But before writing about the spiritual mediums views on Dark Wood I would first like to go back several weeks to when I spent the day with Chris Evers, the Joint Editor of this new paranormal magazine. He wanted to talk to me about my research and where I was going with my forth coming book. (The Truth that leaves no Proof) or Truth Proof for short.

The day Chris came we visited a few places of interest including this particular piece of woodland. I gave him no indication of my own feelings about Dark Wood, other than it might be of interest due to reports of big cats and its alleged resident ghost, the white lady. I had previously took four other people to Dark Wood and all of them felt uneasy in this particular area of the Dyke. So with that in mind I was keen to see its effect on Chris Evers, a man I knew was not prone to flights of fancy.

His first reaction on entering the wood was one of unease and I have to say his whole persona changed from calm and relaxed to becoming a little tense. Chris said he was picking up feelings and moods of a dark nature within minutes of us stepping into the trees. He said he felt bad things had happened there and it was not a happy place to be. This surprised me, I know for a fact he had never been there before and new nothing about this part of Danes Dyke other than it formed part of a huge ancient earth work. I wondered what mechanisms were at work to evoke such emotions, I may have secretly wanted Dark Wood to work its magic on Chris but I don't really think I expected it to have such an effect.

He said he felt human sacrifice had taken place there and the whole area made him feel uncomfortable. I have felt a sense of unease on the many occasions when I spent time there alone but could not put a finger on a reason why. This was my main reason for taking people to the location, I wanted to gauge human emotion to what I feel is a highly unusual place.

I thought about what Chris told me over the weeks that passed, I already knew something was and is not right in Dark Wood. Although I never expected him to say something had an effect on him in such a way. I was sorry Chris felt the way he did inside the wood, but also pleased that his mind was open to other possibilities. We had known each other many years but had rarely talked about other things outside of the UFO phenomena. I believe with the subject of UFOs and the unexplained we should not just be looking in one box for ideas and clues about why these things are seen and experienced. Chris's observations were a jump from the nuts and bolts UFO and this both pleased and surprised me. You would think others with an interest in

this subject would be open to all theories and possibilities; sadly this is not always the case. Which is a shame because we could be missing out on opportunities to access this great unknown from other angles. My day spent with Chris was good and we discussed many things past and present and it became clear that through channels like the Outer Limits magazine no stone would go unturned in the search for the truth.

I did not tell Chris until weeks after that I would be writing about his experience in Dark wood.

I had intended to write an article on the White Lady of Danes Dyke, a ghostly apparition that had been seen and documented for hundreds of years. But apart from reports that she had been seen in Danes Dyke along with other reports of spheres of glowing white light nothing much was known. That was my reason for spending so much time there alone, I wanted a feel for the area. A sense of where the activity was taking place. A small stream runs into the main channel of the Dyke called Gel spring. I wondered if this could be the location where the White Lady had been seen, and was the name Gel somehow derived from Girl say? Whatever the origins of the spring or the White Lady. I felt I had touched on awareness in Dark Wood that was different to anywhere else in the surrounding area. But to add more substance to my suspicions I had to put this unknown feeling to the test. Could a feeling actually be tested ?

It was clear from Chris Evers and other people's reactions a feeling was impressing itself onto them in some indescribable way.

I noted Chris' mood change when entering the wood and with this in mind I knew I wanted to test the area more. To take other experiences with no knowledge of the location or my personal views into the affected area with me. So that they could also be subjected to the high strangeness that tapped into human emotion if such an element existed.

### **How we became acquainted with the Mediums**

The idea that an invisible awareness could affect human emotion intrigued me.

A few weeks before this my good friend and researcher Andi Ramsden had been out with his wife and young children to a place called Skirlington. Here they hold a huge Sunday market with indoor shops and a car boot sale that take a few hours to walk round. By some incredible coincidence the lady who had moved into the house opposite me only days before was there promoting her new business. Which was spiritual holidays and lessons in medium ship. I had seen a poster in the window placed there by the new occupants but could not see what it actually said.

At this point we had not met and I had no idea who had moved into the house over the road. It seems incredible that I was searching for a spiritual medium and Andi Ramsden called me to tell me about speaking to one at Skirlington. The same lady who just happened to have moved to the house over the road

from our own.

Andi says she sat in a small booth and people could go in and she would give them readings and offer healing, it was also her chance to inform people about her forthcoming business. He said that as he walked past he could not help but look inside. The lady's eyes connected with his and she asked if she could speak with him. Without hesitation he stepped inside and said hello. To his surprise she immediately asked him if he had been frightened whilst stood in a field? It was out of the blue, who would ask such a random question for no apparent reason. And who would understand the significance of such a question. Andi understood instantly.

It may have been a odd thing for a complete stranger to ask but it made sense to him. The previous Friday evening we were at RAF Bampton and we had to cut our visit short because he swears that he saw a dark ball or sphere suddenly slip out of the darkness and hover behind my head. We had talked about it in phone conversations all week as it seemed to have affected him. He said at the time it scared him so much he felt as though he could not breath. We were stood opposite the field that looks onto the old radar base when this happened.

The medium said that she could see him stood in a field frightened and she thought a dark energy of some kind had latched onto him. I found this amazing, I don't need to understand the how or the why the words which just fell from her mouth did. But her words confirmed Andis experience and proved to me that she was very genuine. She said wanted to try and remove whatever it was that had attached itself to Andi. I would like to stress that none of the help and advice she offered cost Andi a penny.

Andi phoned me later that day and told me to about meeting this amazing lady who somehow knew about his field of fear encounter. He also said she had just moved to Bridlington from Leeds, I thought little of it until the next morning, that was when I saw the sign in her window about spiritualism. I wondered if some things were meant to be? Later that same day I introduced myself to Janet and her son Karl. I explained how Andi had told me about meeting her at Skirlington and that I was interested in her work and the unexplained. I then offered to take them to a few places of interest around our immediate area, Janet and Karl agreed and we set a date for the next Friday. My plan was set in place.

### **Four visit Dark wood the medium experiment**

Our first stop was Danes Dyke and I wanted to gauge their views /opinions once inside a certain part of the wood. We arrived at about 6pm, it was a warm pleasant evening. The place I was taking them to see was off the usual areas where most people visiting would come for a walk. The four of us casually walked across an open field where the odd gauze bush full of yellow flower broke up the green. We were heading towards a

small finger of woodland that stuck out between two fields. This was the place I had previously found branch anomalies and I have on two occasions heard a strange high pitched sound that seemed to be all around. On both occasions I had witnesses with me when the unusual sounds happened. I wish we could bottle the senses and feelings places evoke for others to experience, good and bad. For now you will just have to rely on my observations and the effects these places have had on other people I have taken to these areas.

So armed with my own experiences and those of others I had taken including OLM Joint Editor, Chris Evers I new the next step in the experiment was to take the mediums to these areas of high strangeness.

As the four of us walked across the field leading to dark wood the air was beginning to cool. It was now 6.15pm and very quiet, a deer ran across our path lifting the mood. I saw that as a good sign and pointed out to Andi, Janet and her son Karl that the presence of the deer meant no one else was around.

The Wood starts and stops at the field edge, it does not lead you in by a steady progression of thickening undergrowth. Immediately on entering the wood Janet stopped and in a swaying movement moved backwards.

“Oh that does not feel good, somethings not right”

These were her first words, We said nothing and let her experience the moment. It was happening almost instantly.

“People have died here Paul, I can see a woman burning. I am getting an image of a Catherine wheel, the type of thing you see on bonfire night. I can see a woman tied to something like this and she is burning. This is not a nice place.”

We got this moments after entering the wood. I cannot explain or deny what she said but to say such things for no apparent reason to me was incredible. We proceeded to make our way into the heart of the tiny stretch of woodland. Our final

destination, the area where I had heard the strange sounds over the previous weeks. Once there the four of us stayed for close to an hour. Janet and her son made great efforts to contact whatever spirit or life forms were around us. She said she felt people in pain and wanted to help them if she could. I made no judgment on her remarks something was happening to people that could only be experienced as an emotion. At this moment Janet was an outlet for the phenomena. With the aid of a crystal that hung from a silver chain she asked questions to the silent woodland. I am not familiar with such things and observed in silence, the crystal turned right for yes and left for no. I cannot say with certainty if some unknown force was answering her questions but I can say they did pick up on the fact that something dark and sinister had taken place inside the wood. Was it an invisible life form capable of tapping into human emotion, or was it our own inner self projecting fear. I would lean towards the former, but was it spirit or other?

I observed how Janet and Karl reacted to the wood and its surroundings. It was interesting to note that no good vibrations were picked up by the mediums. Is it possible that bad things had taken place and were somehow imprinted into the location. I wondered if the experiences being picked up on are real and re-enacting in a never ending loop, some how trapped by or in the area. Or if they are a kind of past memory that lingers and can be seen and experienced by a gifted few. Or are they as I suspect an intelligence that plays with our emotions, sometimes with devastating consequences.

I felt the unease and know for sure the place is different, Chris Evers picked up on what he felt was human sacrifice. And Janet’s observations on the day helped further confirm what had gone before. Is this proof of anything we can understand? I would have to say no. But is it proof that something is taking place that is real but beyond our understanding I would say yes.

#### Four Visit RAF Bampton

After our walk into Dark Wood the four of us decided that it would still be good to visit Bampton. There was still plenty of day light left and it was not that cold. Things had gone well in the wood and I was keen to see if Janet could pick up anything unusual around the old RAF base. I had already stressed to Andi that we should say nothing about the location of field of fear. The place Janet had already picked up on weeks before when they met at the Sunday market.

We arrived at the RSPB (Bird Sanctuary) at about 7.30pm parked the car and proceeded to walk down to the cliffs. It was beginning to get cold but nothing like the nights me and Andi had spent up there in winter. Anyone who has ever stood on the cliff tops off Flambrough and Bampton on a cold night in December will tell you it is no pleasant experience. The wind chill coming off the North Sea is cutting. Bampton and Flambrough have a four foot high fence running along its cliff tops to prevent any one accidentally walking over the edge of its two to four hundred foot cliffs. Our destination was an area between the cliffs and the old radar station that was RAF Bampton.

Until this point Janet's son Karl had been rather quiet and allowed his mum to sense and feel the surroundings within Dark Wood, he said very little on our journey towards the base. We paused to look at the 21 concrete pillars that once formed a part of the radar bases work on the experimental Project Winkle I, in the 50s & 60s. I observed that Karl moved away from the three of us and appeared a little unsteady on his feet. I left Janet and Andi to talk and I walked towards him, I could tell something was wrong. I reached out and held his upper arm and asked him if he was ok.

“ I feel dizzy and I don’t like this place. ” Karl said.

I assured him we were fine, no one was around and we were safe. He stood holding the perimeter fence and for a moment

I thought he was going to climb over it. I held his arm and guided him away from the fence. At that moment Janet and Andi shouted out.

“Wow did you see that.”

We turned to look at them, they were pointing to one of the disused RAF buildings situated about 200 yards between us and the cliff edge. It had a large dark opening of 6ft by 7ft where huge steel doors would have once hung. This was where they were pointing but we could see nothing to indicate why they were so excited. Andi and Janet were now staring at each other asking the same question.

“Did you see it, did you see that.”

Whatever they had seen had taken them both by surprise and seemed to take the edge of Karl's anxiety.

They both nodded and confirmed what the other had apparently seen. Before we could ask they turned to us and said we just saw something very strange in that doorway. A solid looking bar of white light suddenly appeared in the middle of the opening. A bit like a four foot fluorescent tube hung vertical in the doorway. It appeared then vanished just as fast. All I could do was take their word as I was talking with Karl at the time they saw the tube of light. I was annoyed with myself that I never got to see it but also intrigued that Karl appeared to be having some kind of unpleasant experience when they claimed the light appeared?

The buildings that remain on the cliff tops have no power and the windows and doors have long since gone. They have been derelict since the early 1970s. All that remains are a cluster of reinforced concrete shells that contain nothing but cow dung and cobwebs so what caused the light to appear in the doorway we will never know. I glanced at Karl who now seemed to have settled down a little, I suspect Andi and his mums story of the light took over his thought process. For a few minutes we all focused on the dark doorway hoping for a repeat showing of the light but nothing happened.

I have written extensively about the missing people of Bempton and Flambrough in my book Truth Proof. And it is interesting to note that where we were stood is in the area where many of these people have vanished. Dark Wood and this location close to RAF Bempton were the places I wanted to take the medium and it seems the area did not disappoint. The fact that we were also very close to where Andi says he saw the dark orb of light weeks before throws even more mystery onto this location. At this point we still had not told Janet or her son that we were actually stood in the field where the dark orb appeared and I am not sure if it was a second sense or she just knew. But without hesitation she turned to Andi and told him she felt this was the place he became frightened.

Before we left Andi asked her if we could put some questions to the unknown life-force that we suspected lingered in the ar-

ea. Janet's questions were aimed at spirit and she could be right, I lean towards any unknown other? Moments later she drew the silver chain from her pocket and we proceeded to ask. Our first question was.

“Have people gone missing around this place.” The crystal slowly turned to the right indicating an answer of yes.

“Are you human.” The crystal never moved.

“Were the people who vanished happy before they left.” The crystal began to turn to the right then abruptly stopped. We all saw this, it stopped dead.

“That's odd, I don't really no what that means. It's the first time it has ever done that.” She rolled the chain into her palm and put it back in her pocket.

We decided it was time to head back to the car, it was now approaching 8.30pm and would be dark by the time we arrived back in Bridlington. On the way home Janet and Andi continued to discuss the bar of white light, they seemed eager to impress upon me and Karl that it was real and that they both did see it. I glanced back at Karl, I wondered if his panic attack moments before they saw the light was in some way connected?

A short time later we arrived back on our street, said our good-byes and went our separate ways. I had not been home for more than 15 minutes when the doorbell rang. I opened the door to see Janet stood in front of me, she appeared unsettled. She had clearly come to give me a message.

“Paul I had to come over and tell you, Soon as Karl got home he told me that he never ever wants to go to Bempton cliffs again. Karl is a genuine medium Paul, he does not even work it the way I do he only came along to see the area. It is just the way he is. He says that he could hear people screaming all around him, voices of people in pain. I don't know what has happened up on those cliff tops Paul but it's a very strange place. At one point he says it made him feel ill. He really is upset by this.”

I asked her if he said anything about when we were in Dark Wood, she said he never mention the wood. Only that the cliffs scared him and he never wanted to go there again. I am not sure what to take away from this experience, it is true that many UFO/Paranormal researchers would shun the idea of using a medium in an attempt to find answers. I would ask those same researchers to show me their Proof.

It is clear to me from the people I took into dark wood something was affecting human emotion. I think our trip to Bempton will in time reveal even more than what we were shown with Janet Andi and Karl.

Time will tell...



# The Alien Abduction account of Rosalind Reynolds

In the 1990's I was fortunate enough to become involved in the research and investigation of a number of close encounter cases better known as cases of 'alien abduction'. The bulk of my research was published in the book I co-authored with journalist Carl Nagaitis entitled 'WITHOUT CONSENT'. I travelled the length and breadth of the UK to interview witnesses to both well known events and many cases that were totally unknown. There were a number of witnesses that stood out for me and one such was Rosalind Reynolds. Rosalind was one of a few brave enough at the time to go public with her account which I will relate here in brief. I caught up with Rosalind in September 2013 to ask what it was like and what happened to her once she went public. But first her story:



It was September of 1982 and CB radio fan Rosalind Reynolds and her boyfriend at the time Philip were on a late summers drive through East Anglia when an encounter with a UFO changed her life forever. The couple had set off from Clacton in Essex and they were enroute to Corby in Northamptonshire to meet up with relatives. The approximate journey time

was two and a half hours and they were both looking forward to it. They had stopped for some food after leaving Clacton and were heading towards Sudbury. It was a nice warm evening and the car windows were down the radio was playing. On the outskirts of Sudbury they drove under a string of electricity pylons which spread out across the hillside.

Suddenly they were confronted by a strange configuration of lights as they emerged from underneath the power lines. A horseshoe-shaped set of lights was approaching them at high

speed. The multi-coloured, mostly orange and red object swooped low over their car. It was at this point that Rosalind noticed the silence and stillness that seemed to surround them. As the UFO moved across the sky a flash of blue electric light illuminated everything around her. "It made everything look like a photo-negative," recalled Rosalind. A peculiar, foul smell, almost like rotten eggs seemed to be coming from the object. The odour became stronger the closer it got.

Bemused by the whole event the couple drove on through Sudbury and at Long Milford joined the A604 towards Haverhill. As Philip concentrated on the driving Rosalind took in the surrounding countryside. It was at this point that her eyes glimpsed something in the distance. "Look another one," she shouted, pointing to an oval-shaped object that seemed to be heading towards them. Philip thought it might be a plane but Rosalind was adamant that it was heading in their direction. "Why would a plane draw level with us?" she asked as she looked across to see a ball of light pacing their car. Philip was having none of it and continued to drive on.

Rosalind tried to ignore the thing that was following them but it was no good, she knew it was there. Philip simply refused to acknowledge it no matter what. They drove on and suddenly they were plunged into darkness. The car's engine and electrics cut out and the disabled car rolled to a stop. "Philip was glued



to the steering wheel, looking straight ahead as if he had blinkers on” remembered Rosalind. She assumed that, like she, he was shocked and scared by the presence of the UFO. The thing was now so close they could not avoid looking at it. Big, bright and round sitting just sixty feet away from them. “It was like a big ball of light with lots of little lights around it,” Rosalind told investigators later.

The couple reluctantly climbed out of the car and lifted the bonnet to see if they could find out what had caused it to stop. The way the car had stopped seemed as if its battery had just suddenly been drained. As they stood looking at the cars engine its headlights came back on. The couple looked at each other and Philip jumped back in the driver’s seat and tried the ignition. It started first time. Rosalind climbed in and they drove off leaving the UFO behind them. After putting some distance between themselves and the UFO the couple finally began to relax. Then a few miles further away Rosalind saw what she thought was the same object again shooting straight up into the sky with a pencil-thin blue light streaming out behind it.

Glad to be on their way again they seemed to make good progress but when they got to Corby their host was not answering their knock on the door. After a while, a bedroom window opened and someone asked: “What time do you call this? It’s half past one in the morning.” Their two and a half hour journey had taken five and a half hours. Rosalind and Philip were stunned by the events of that night, and by their missing hours. But the after effects of that encounter would be equally astonishing. Within months the couple broke up after six years together.” He was a different person, not the Philip I knew,” said Rosalind.

Rosalind had changed too. She dramatically lost weight, despite developing a craving for sweets, especially chocolate, and went down to just six stones. She gave up drinking and smoking and suddenly became creative, speedily writing complicated scientific papers on such topics as: How The Universe Was Formed and What Religion Really Is. But Rosalind was desperate to discover why she had lost three hours from her life. What had happened on that summer’s evening?

Rosalind saw the chance to discover why she had three hours of missing time when she spotted an article in her local newspaper about a UFO group in East Anglia. Rosalind




made contact with the group and eventually they arrange a session of regressive hypnosis. The hypnosis took place at Rosalind’s home but it went disastrously wrong. A Bright beam of light came into the room, the video recording was wiped out and all the clocks stopped,” said Rosalind. After the abandoned hypnosis session Rosalind was advised to see a psychic and was introduced to the man she would eventually

marry. Mark Reynolds-Parnham was that man.

Mark arranged a second hypnosis session in which Rosalind was taken back to her 1983 encounter. She recalled being approached by four or five small beings after their car had stopped. The aliens, for that is what she assumed they were, forced her into their craft. They took her to an examination room where she was undressed and laid on a clear Perspex-like table for observation. Rosalind became agitated, embarrassed and frightened during the hypnosis session. She described how the aliens undressed her and laid her on the table but then she became quiet. Suddenly Rosalind sat bolt upright in her chair and screamed: “no I don’t want any babies,” So concerned were the hypnosis team by Rosalind’s distress in trance, they decided to end the session. Rosalind is convinced that she underwent some kind of gynaecological procedure but still prefers not to speak about her hypnosis session.

Since that night she has suffered irregular menstruation which she feels has cost her the chance of having children. Medical tests failed to find a cause for the problem. Rosalind also reports an unexplained scar in her groin area, which she assumed is linked to her abduction experience. Additionally she developed a buzzing in her head which troubles her to this day.



Rosalind says the after effects of that encounter were truly devastating to her. The initial weight loss left her friends and family worried that she might be anorexic and she worried about her missing periods. “I could not talk to anybody about these things because I thought they would think I was a freak,” said Rosalind. “I just bottled it up. I became a recluse for a while worrying about what had happened.”

Rosalind’s husband Mark has helped her come to terms with her experience, but she now believes she may well have had UFO encounters in the past; there are other events of missing time that she finds hard to ignore.

Rosalind was one of a handful of ‘abductees’ who went public with her experiences when my book was published in the mid-1990’s. I have occasionally kept in touch with her since then but in early 2009 I wanted to ask what it was like for her going public. How was she treated by both friends and family. A short question and answer session was arranged and this is what she had to say:

Q: How did your friends and family react when you told them about your experience?

A: My friends just laughed and joked about it. I was really worried about that night and everyone just thought it was a laugh. From then onwards all my friends just backed off and I saw less and less of them. I found it difficult to tell my mother, she was away working abroad and when she returned it was a few weeks after the event. By then with my experience of my friends I just thought it best to keep it to myself. We were never close anyway, so she would not have noticed anything out of the ordinary. I have no other family other than my mother.

Q: You eventually went public with your experience, how did members of the public react?

A: It was embarrassing. I found walking down the street difficult as people would jeer or whistle “UFO” style tunes after me. After a while I grew a thick skin and nowadays if asked “have you seen any UFO’S lately?” I tend to joke back at them. And if they whistle a tune such as close encounters, I tell them to get up to date it’s the X files they should be singing. The strangest thing is I get jeered at to this day!

Q: How were you treated by the media?

A: To my face they seemed very sincere and genuinely interested in what I had experienced, but all they seemed interested in was “what did they do to me in the ship? Did they put anything up my... well I leave the rest to your imagination. Once the interviews went out I found they were badly edited to show a completely different story focusing on what happened to me, it was played up to be a kind of joke with the addition of some corny music and voice over and invariably at the end of my interview an “expert” who had never had an experience in his life was brought on to say why it could NOT have happened. Of course I never was offered a chance to question the “expert” or put my side back to his argument. Of course the Newspaper ones were frightening with headlines like “ALIENS STOLE MY WOMB”! How could a journalist seem so sincere to my face then write things up like that?

Q: How did UFO researchers react to your experience?

A: Well that was a difficult one as I naively believed they had the answers. After all that is why I contacted them when I found out such clubs (not necessarily researches) existed. My first encounter with a UFO group who I approached, I was invited to their meeting, told to sit in a corner and not allowed to talk to anyone by the club owner. I was chaperoned and found



all the questions were answered by the person who had invited me to the club and I couldn’t say a thing. I felt instead of getting answers, I was some kind of prize to be brought out and displayed. It was very upsetting. I wanted genuine answers to genuine questions. Cold hard facts and I felt I was amongst a group of extremists who would believe a spot of light in the sky was a UFO without questioning the object or anything.

Then I met researchers such as Jenny Randles and Philip Mantle. I have a lot of time for them and the greatest of respect. They have a tough time and the public and media give them a tougher time. They made me feel like a person again and that there was something in it. I was not something to be exploited and that I had experienced something. More importantly they believed me and gave me the courage to go back and try and find my own answers.

age to go back and try and find my own answers.

Q: Did you feel that regressive hypnosis was a benefit or not and would you recommend its use in future research?

A: I absolutely believe that in the wrong hands this type of thing can do more damage than good. My own experience produced an exceptionally strange effect and which to this day has affected those in the room with me at the time. This simply compounded the belief that something other than what we know in our own world was happening. Sometimes it is bigger than any of us, and not the time for us to know. Let it be until the time is right. If you have a block, then let it take its own time to lift. Do not push it; it is there for a reason. If hypnosis is the only way then it must be under controlled conditions and by a professional who is a trained professional in psychiatry as well as hypnosis

Q: Do you regret at all going public with your account?

A: I regret that the media cannot seem to present the information with the same sensitivity they would a rape victim’s account, and through the bad presentation, the public see us as a laughing stock, side show or freak. Properly handled and presented then the public can see there are many depths to life and not to laugh at it. They still can easily accept a ghost story, or a religious event, yet the mere mention of “aliens” sends them

into giggles, sniggering at us as we walk past. At least my story going public has hopefully meant that others who were lost could now at least see they were not alone. Others who had experiences no matter of what nature could take heart they were not going mad, or something was happening to them they could not talk to anyone else about. If I have helped one person who has had an experience deal with their own experience then I do not regret going public one bit.

Q: Looking back now what do you feel is the nature and origin of your experience?

A: I think this could be a book on its own as it is complex. To this day I am still split between two theories. The logical side to me says that we (my boyfriend and I) inadvertently were present when an experimental craft using some form of unknown technology had a malfunction. It did not crash, but something could have been wrong with it and we were in the wrong place at the wrong time. However, I still have very vivid recollections of beings and other things on the craft, so it leaves me with the second theory it was actual aliens as in not of the world we live in and not necessarily outer space, other world type aliens. Either way it was technology not of the world we know. I have theories of it being inter-dimensional, as there are many depths and heights to the space we exist in, many phases. One of which is the ghost, or spirit world for instance. My biggest question still remains. WHY ME? I found out just before my mother died that she too had experiences. These were backed up as just before my father died. Independently and totally not knowing of my experience or that my mother had told me hers, he told me of his and his brothers recollections which tied in to just before my conception. This leads me to believe maybe there are certain lines of humanity that are being monitored for reasons we are not aware of? I could write a book on the information I know and believe but the hard facts are. I have scars, I have medical history.

What we experienced was for real and there was nothing around to my knowledge and through my investigation which could have manoeuvred the way that craft did then. Those facts alone mean that either theory fits.

Q: What would you like to say to the sceptics who dismiss all such accounts?

A: I think this sums it up nicely 'When you have eliminated the impossible, whatever remains, however improbable, must be the truth.' Sherlock Holmes.

And I say that to both the sceptics, who would insist I saw the moon when there was no moon that night and to the other end

of the scale, to the people I have met who go to UFO clubs who would believe without question a light to be a UFO when it is nothing more than a light, I put that to both equally.

I have spent many years looking at my experience with cold hard eyes, trying to find the truth. It doesn't matter to me what they (the sceptics) want to believe, but I feel that they should look at each case as an individual one and not try to label us

all the same, as it is exactly that, a unique experience to each person. We have been given a gift, a chance to see a new life a new way the universe works. Who are we to judge why? And who are the sceptics to say it didn't happen if it enriches our lives, and hurts no one?

Rosalind Reynolds

I was and still am grateful to Rosalind for going on the record with her experience and for allowing me to share it both in my book and here in this article. I don't pretend to have the answers to the abduction experience and there are some wise words spoken here by her. I have no doubt though that Rosalind Reynolds did experience what has become to be known as an 'alien abduction' of that I am sure.

If you have had such an experience and are unsure whether or not to go public with it then perhaps Rosalind's words above may be of some assistance to you. Rosalind Reynolds is now aged 51 and lives with her 11 year old son Nathaniel in Lincolnshire. A single parent she runs her own business and is a well known dog breeder and dog show judge.

In 2013 I published my first work of fiction entitled 'ONCE UPON A MISSING TIME – A novel of alien abduction'. Although fiction this book is loosely based on a number of close encounters cases in the UK. Rosalind Reynolds is but one of those that had a big influence on the book. The book in question is now available in paperback and kindle via Amazon.

# Commander Alan Turner MBE

## RAF Sopley UFO-1971

At the UFO DATA conference in October 2007 I met up with veteran UFO investigator David Beezer. I've known David for many years and he has regularly attended many of our public events. David wanted me to read a report he had received from a former RAF officer but on the day I simply did not have the time. David made me a copy of the report in question and I read it a day or two after the conference had finished.

The report came from a Mr. Alan Turner MBE and concerned a UFO observed on radar at RAF Sopley in the summer of 1971. I subsequently contact Mr. Turner and have his permission to document the following. His report is published in full.

Alan Turner was aged twenty-five when he joined the Royal Air Force in 1966 and was commissioned that year as an Air Traffic Control Officer. RAF Sopley was a wartime bunker, which had been converted into a joint military/civilian Air Traffic Control Radar Unit (ATCRU): it closed in 1974 when both the civil and military ATC functions were transferred to West Drayton.

Alan Turner remained in the RAF eventually to command the Central ATC School from 1990 to 1992. In July 1995 he was discharged from the RAF in the rank of Wing Commander.

This is Wing Commanders Turner's account of what he personally observed at RAF Sopley in the summer of 1971 in full:

In the summer of 1971 I was the Duty Military Supervisor at RAF Sopley, which was a joint military/civil Air Traffic Control Radar Unit (ATCRU). It was a Tuesday afternoon but I cannot remember the exact date. The Duty Civil Supervisor drew my attention to a situation on radar the likes of which neither of us had ever encountered.

Emanating from a point some twenty nautical miles east of the eastern extremity of the Salisbury Plain Danger Area were a series of six or seven blips moving on a south-easterly track each being separated from the other by about six miles. At about forty miles from the point they appeared on radar they disappeared to be followed almost immediately by a replacement at the point of origin.

I put the FPS 6 Height Finder onto some returns to discover that they were about 3000 feet when they came into radar cover and climbing extremely rapidly so that, by the time they disappeared from radar, they were in excess of 60,000 feet. To climb to such a height in only forty miles was beyond the ability of any fighter aircraft at the time.

The phenomenon was witnessed by four civil and six military controllers on duty at the time. I called Heathrow Radar to discover that they, also, were seeing a similar picture. The same situation prevailed in the Fighter Control Operations Rooms at RAF Neatishead. The three units involved operated different radars from each other thus different frequencies were in use. The weather forecast from the south of England was calm and sunny. I called the Met Office to confirm the strength of the upper winds to find that they were also relatively calm and were about fifty degrees off the south-easterly track of the blips; they also confirmed that there were not Met balloons/probes airborne at the time.

The winds were not strong enough, nor in the right direction, to cause the blips to travel on their observed track especially at the speed they were travelling. It was estimated that they were doing around 250 knots, but it must be borne in mind that this was a lateral speed as seen on radar – they must have been travelling very much faster to climb over 50,000 feet in less than forty miles. Equally the weather was such that there were no 'angels' to affect the radar picture. "Angels" was a euphemism for, what were believed to be, ionized pockets of air which, under very specific atmospheric conditions, were often seen on radar screens in those days: when seen, these 'angels' travelled

extremely slowly simply drifting along haphazard tracks. In those days all radars were 'raw'. That is to say that, whatever was within the coverage of the radar envelope and capable of bouncing (returning) the radar pulse back to the receiver, would be seen on the radar tube. Today's radars are computerised thus such interference is processed out so as not to affect the picture.

Looking around for some other method of checking what was going on, I discovered that a controller had two Canberra's on frequency returning from Germany. One of the pilots agreed to investigate so I assumed control of his aircraft and, having confirmed he was in good visual met conditions, I vectored him on to the blips keeping him regularly updated on their position relative to the Canberra.

The aircraft was flying at around nineteen thousand feet and when it got within a mile or so of one particular blip, the pilot reported, in a very agitated voice, that his radar had picked something up heading down his port side by about a quarter of a mile and 'climbing like the clappers', it was on a reciprocal heading to the Canberra. The pilot admitted that neither he nor his navigator made any visual contact and confirmed that the weather conditions were such that they would have had no difficulty seeing something that close.

The whole episode lasted for twenty minutes or more before the blips stopped appearing. I impounded the R/T tapes and the Radar Video film and made appropriate entries in the log. Each person in the Ops Room who witnessed the incident was required to write a report. The Squadron Leader in charge of Operations collated the reports and informed higher authority. Within a couple of days I was interviewed in the Squadron Leader's office by two men who were not identified to me. I, along with all the others in the Ops Room on the day in question, were told in no uncertain terms not to relate what we had seen until cleared to do so.

About four years later I was serving at RAF Wattisham when

the Station Commander asked to see me. I was told that he had a communication from the MoD about the incident at Sopley and that as 'nothing could be confirmed' the situation was such that doubt would be cast on anything I said about it. I took this to mean that I was no longer to remain silent.

I am at a loss to explain what I, and many other people, saw. In those days aircraft could not climb at such a rate. To be seen on displays by three different ground radars, plus the airborne radar in the Canberra, is also a mystery. The weather conditions were very definitely VMC or Visual Met Conditions; the aircraft was clear of cloud by at least a thousand feet vertically and with a forward visibility of at least five nautical miles.

In Mr. Turner's letter to be dated 10<sup>th</sup> November 2007 he apologised for not remembering the exact date of the incident and believes that there are those out there that will use this to discredit his account. I'll leave you with his final comments on the incident; "Please use the information in any way you see fit; I stand by what I saw because I know what I saw."

# If Roswell Happened TODAY (part 1)

## Introduction

One of the questions I'm most frequently asked is what the MoD would do if a UFO crashed (or indeed landed) in the UK. Is there a plan? Who would be involved? Would the government try to cover it up? In this two-part article I'll be setting out the issues and - hopefully - fuelling some discussion and debate. In relation to the issue of genuine extra-terrestrial contact, there are a range of scenarios that could arise. These fall into four broad categories and I shall deal with the first three relatively quickly, before focusing on the idea of a UFO crash, as this latter concept - largely due to Roswell - is so embedded in the minds of the UFO community.

## Alien Invasion

Scenario one is an alien invasion and there's little that I can say about this that isn't wild speculation. In a field where it's foolhardy to make assumptions (I've often heard ufologists make bold statements beginning with phrases such as "well, aliens wouldn't do that because ...") one of the few logical assumptions we can legitimately make is that any extra-terrestrials visiting Earth will have a more advanced technology than ours, on the basis that they will have viable interstellar travel, whereas our space programme is in its infancy. Despite the odds, it's in our nature to fight and I speculated what might happen in my two science fiction novels, Operation Thunder Child and Operation Lightning Strike - the only sci-fi novels ever to have needed government clearance prior to publication. Incidentally, in October 2007, US Presidential candidate Rudolph Giuliani was asked by an 8 year old boy how the US would respond if it did ever encounter hostile extra-terrestrials. He said that the US would deal with the situation, but he was clearly unprepared

for the question and had no real idea what to say. Go to YouTube and put the two words "Giuliani" and "alien" into the search box, if you want to watch the exchange.

## Benign First Contact

Scenario two is almost as speculative as scenario one, so again, there's little one can say. As with scenario one, the reasonable assumption is that if 'they' discover you, 'they' are your technological superiors. This is one of the more interesting concepts in a paper entitled "UFO Hypothesis and Survival Questions", which can be found on the NSA website and which explores some of these speculative issues about contact with extra-terrestrials. Suffice to say, given that visiting extra-terrestrials are likely to be our technological superiors, it's more likely than not that they would set the agenda. Needless to say, it's to be hoped that benign first contact would include exchanges of information that might lead to our acquiring considerable scientific knowledge and technology.

## Finding a Signal

Scenario three is the detection of a signal by means of radio astronomy. The Search for Extra-terrestrial Intelligence (SETI) community is an active one and indeed 11 October 2007 was inauguration day for the Allen Telescope Array, which the SETI Institute believes will "shift SETI into third gear". Even that pales into insignificance when compared to the power of the Square Kilometre Array (SKA), where construction is scheduled to begin in 2011, with the facility fully operational by 2020. Many in the SETI community believe that if there are civilizations using radio anywhere within 100 light years of

Earth, SKA will be able to detect them. I often wish that the UFO community and the SETI community got along better. It seems to me that you want the same thing and that the only thing that sets you apart is your methodology. Like it or not, SETI is going from strength to strength and I've said before that I think it far more likely that proof that we're not alone will come from the SETI community rather than from ufologists. As to what would happen if a signal was found, a "Post-Detection SETI Protocol" has been drafted by the International Academy of Astronautics. While not legally binding, it's probably the best available guide to how the scientific community should respond and what issues are likely to arise. A quick Google search will turn up the document.

### **UFO Crash**

Our fourth and final scenario is the idea of a UFO crash. Of course, there will be those who say that this has already happened, in places such as the Berwyn Mountains, Cannock Chase or even the Llandegla Moors near Wrexham. Personally, I do not find the evidence for such British UFO crashes compelling, though as ever, I try to keep an open mind. Returning to our scenario, again, there are many variables. But we have to start somewhere, so let's take a hypothetical situation and run with it. Let's suppose that a UFO crashes in a remote part of the UK.

The first question is, would there be any witnesses? Even when aircraft crash in remote areas, TV news reports almost invariably turn up a witness who saw - or at least heard - something, so the chances are, it would be noticed. As with Roswell, it's statistically likely that the first witness or witnesses would be members of the public. The next question is, who are they going to call? Despite the UFO community's focus on the MoD, people's basic instinct will be to call the police and - if they think an aircraft has crashed - the other emergency services.

### **The Police**

It's likely that the police will be first responders and again, there are all sorts of variables. It may be that they are confronted by a debris field of unidentifiable wreckage, or it may be that a more obvious craft is recognisable. Dependant upon what it looks like (and on issues such as whether any extra-terrestrial entities - dead or alive - are found) they may assume it's an alien spacecraft, or a terrestrial satellite, aircraft or UAV. In either event, their first action should be to cordon off the site and treat it as a crime scene. Follow up actions will include locating and interviewing witnesses, and recovering and analysing evidence. They may decide to call in the Ministry of Defence Police or the Service (i.e. military) Police, but the local Chief Constable would have primacy, even if others had jurisdiction.

### **MoD and the Military**

Notwithstanding the Chief Constable's jurisdiction and primacy,

he or she would probably, sooner rather than later, decide to call in the MoD and the military. Military Aid to the Civil Authorities (MACA) is often requested at times of national crisis or when large numbers of trained, disciplined people are required. MACA has taken place in the aftermath of floods, the Lockerbie disaster, the foot and mouth disease outbreak and the fuel crisis, to name just a few incidents. For those that want to do further research into this, a number of publications are available. "Military Aid to the Civil Community in the UK - a pamphlet for the guidance of Civil Authorities and Organisations" - the so-called Blue Book - is available from HMSO. "MACA in UK in Peace" is an internal MoD document sometimes referred to as the Green Book. Finally, there is a Home Office publication entitled "Dealing with Disaster", that provides the framework within which the more detailed plans of the emergency services, local authorities and other organisations are normally prepared. All of these documents provide some clues as to how a UFO crash might be handled, as does the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for an aircraft crash. In other words, while there's no specific plan for a UFO crash, there are plans and processes that could quickly be adapted. But will "quickly" be good enough?

### **Biohazard**

The biggest single issue that might arise is a potential biological hazard. In "The War of the Worlds", terrestrial microbes prove deadly to the invading Martians. In reality, the potential hazard is just as likely to work in reverse. The police would automatically cordon the crash site, because this is an action that would spring automatically from their training, but would they think to test for a biohazard or take any actions to mitigate the risk? This is less clear. Of course, the MoD has various equipment and specialists that can help with detection and decontamination. Readers may recall seeing television reports of a recent exercise designed to test the response to a chemical or biological terrorist attack on the London Underground. But in all of this, timing is critical and if nobody thinks to call such equipment and personnel to the site of a UFO crash immediately, vital time is lost and the chances of containing a biohazard diminish rapidly. Faced with an extra-terrestrial bacteria or virus against which we would have no defence, the worst case scenario is nothing short of the death of every living organism on the face of our planet. If such a disease was seen to be spreading out from the crash site, a British Prime Minister may have to consider using any means available - including the use of nuclear weapons - to completely sterilize the area. This is why the lack of a dedicated plan for a UFO crash exposes us to a critical risk. However unlikely you think it is, there should be a plan. Using the language of risk assessment, this is the ultimate Low Probability/High Consequence (sometimes known as Low Probability/High Impact) event.

### **Enemy Attack and the UFO Potential**

One honourable exception to the notion that there isn't a plan for this sort of thing is the second edition of the book "Fire Officer's Guide to Disaster Control", by William M. Kramer and Charles W. Bahme. Chapter 13 is entitled "Enemy Attack and the UFO Potential" and if readers Google that phrase, they'll be able to read the text. Again, it gives an insight into some of the issues that may arise and some of the ways in which a UFO crash might be dealt with. Incidentally, before anyone wonders, I have deliberately not mentioned Project Moon Dust or Project Blue Fly so far. While many ufologists believe such projects relate to the recovery of crashed or downed UFOs, I believe they were set up to ensure the timely recovery of decidedly more terrestrial (e.g. Soviet) hardware. Be that as it may, I have decided that these matters are outside the scope of this article, though some pertinent issues arise.

### COBRA

Another key player in our unfolding scenario is COBRA. This is the Civil Contingencies Committee, which takes its name from the room where it meets, Cabinet Office Briefing Room A, in Downing Street. COBRA met in the aftermath of the 9/11 terrorist attacks, the 7/7 attack and many other national emergencies. Attendees would vary according to the nature of the crisis, but might include the Prime Minister, senior government ministers, police and intelligence chiefs. The secretariat function is provided by civil servants in the Cabinet Office - the department that co-ordinates action when a situation involves several government departments. One issue the committee could consider is whether to invoke powers in Part Two of the Civil Contingencies Act, which gives considerable extra powers at the time of a serious emergency. Under such powers, Parliament can be suspended, freedom of movement limited, property requisitioned or destroyed. Again, a Google search on terms such as COBRA, Civil Contingencies Committee and Civil Contingencies Act will reveal much interesting and relevant information.

### Next Steps

Numerous other issues arise, many of which relate to MoD's handling of the issue. Because while the Cabinet Office and COBRA would doubtless take a co-ordinating role, MoD (not least by virtue of having responsibility for policy on UFOs and investigation of sightings) would quickly emerge as the lead department. Questions that would need to be handled range from what to tell Ministers, through to how to handle the media. What would Parliament be told? And critically, for conspiracy theorists, would there be any attempt to cover up such an incident? Could it be done and what would the reason be for such an action? All this and more will be revealed in Part 2 of this article. *(continued in Issue 5 Dec 1 2016)*

# ABDUCTION At Roswell!

by David Seals

Where to begin?

Abduction has never really been a big part of the 1947 Roswell story before, at least not in the sense of human kidnapping or abuse. It's always been a mystery or a crime novel in the context of political intrigue and extra-terrestrial paranormal science, investigated by many excellent Sherlock Holmes' digging into a nefarious cover-up by the United States Air Force and villainous government agents foiling unexplainable sightings of Flying Saucers, brainwashing out forgotten memories of eyewitnesses, decades later, who saw 'alien' bodies and crashed spaceships and extra-natural debris from the disappeared things.

And yet, in a way, that's just what the famous front-page headline on July 8, 1947 was saying, when the editors of the Roswell Daily Record interpreted a USAF press release about it that they had "captured" a Flying Saucer in New Mexico.

Captured. Abducted? Was it like a military operation, or a psychological one.

Where was the proof? Where did it end?

In my family, who was there, Roswell had always been an intensely personal place because that was where our parents were married in 1946 and the family began.

It was where 26-year old Lt. Walter J. Seals was a pilot with the 509th Composite Bomb Group that had just come back from nuking Japan at Hiroshima and Nagasaki, and he celebrated the victory by marrying a sassy nurse from Arizona named Kathleen O'Brien (whose father had

fought alongside Mick Collins for Irish independence back in the 1920s).

And then his own airplanes were "captured" too, twice, in a matter of weeks in that epochal Spring and Summer of '47 after winning World War II; but this time not by the German or Japanese enemies.

"Missing time" took his PT-19 trainer on a night flight over the Capitan Mountains west of Roswell - mountains that were sacred to the local Mescalero Apaches as the homes of their otherworldly "Spirit" ancestors - when he saw a "Bogie" cruise up alongside his starboard wing. It was the last thing he remembered until he was sitting in his cockpit, safe and sound back on the ground at the Roswell Base.

The second time, in July '47, he was co-pilot with Lt. Colonel Arthur Exon in a C-47 Gooney Bird on a flight from Lowry AFB in Denver to Roswell to "pick up some cargo from a crash", as he described it to me and my sisters years later, on audiotape.

They flew over the crash site northwest of Roswell, near those same Capitan Mountains, and saw gouges in the ground, and a crumpled spaceship stuck in the side of an arroyo, and 2 other "satellite devices" farther back out in the desert. "Colonel Exon told me," he told us, "several pilots were killed and he had seen them in the Air Force mortuary at Lowry. They looked human, but short, and small, he said."

They landed at the Base and a truck brought in the Device "about the size of a Sputnik satellite, too small for any people

or pilots," and they loaded it in the Gooney Bird. He was ordered to fly it to Luke AFB in Phoenix to an electronic lab crew waiting there.

But they never made it. Not long after take-off, Dad said, a "giant black cloud or something blacked out the stars, and the next thing any of us knew in the crew we were landing at a small municipal airport in Flagstaff, hours later. And the Device was gone. It was just gone from the plane." He said he got in a lot of trouble with CIC (Counterintelligence Corps) for not reporting to Luke, but they had no explanation. The whole Flight was just lost.

These are just a few of the narratives my father told us over the years, some of which are in my book 'Abduction at Roswell'. {Some of them are not, as they require a far more extensive bibliography and footnotes than this book can accommodate, as I'm working on a huge history 'Roswell 1941-1948'. I've tried to document as much of it as I can, as he was a "pack-rat" and kept trunks and trunks of old Air Force mimeos of his orders, etc..., until he died in 1991 with the rank of Lt. Colonel. He obviously didn't want me to write about this or talk about it, at least not while he was alive, or else "he'd go to Leavenworth Prison for 20 years."

But with his death, and Mom's in 2001, it seemed time. An extensive pile of notes have filled a whole shelf over a lifetime of research and interest in literature and UFOs. Included here is Chapter 6 'Back to Japan' from the book, where we'd been stationed in Tokyo at Haneda AFB in the 1950s and I first became aware of the Martians (as we



Scores of great scientists and crime investigators have scoured just about every shard of missing evidence and forgotten memories of witnesses ever since, up to this day, but they have basically come to another dead end. The American Government either won't talk about what they know, or they don't know anything and don't have a "captured" ship or aliens or anything else.

Outstanding researchers, young and old, are banging their heads against a brick wall desperately trying to track down the truth or "the smoking gun" of hard physical metal, bodies, documents - anything to prove once and for all to a sceptical world that desperately "wants to believe" there is something substantial and solid about all these endless X-Files of worldwide sightings by millions of frightened, hopeful people.

They were stuck, though. None of the world's governments were talking. The second generation's iconoclastic conviction that conspiracies were covering up the truth had gone nowhere. There wasn't a peep of extra-terrestrial life from the vast array of satellites and radio radars listening for sounds of life in the universe, nor had telescopes even beyond the earth's orbit, or probes landing on Mars, found a single microbe of vitality. A questionable meteorite found in Antarctica suggested some microbial life on our sister red planet millions of years ago, and water ice was found on a few moons of Saturn and maybe Neptune, but that was about it. No cities and forests and rivers were found by repeated voyagers on the dark side of the moon as George Adamski wrote in 1955.

But ... on the other hand, there were some other tantalizing suggestions there was something else going on that may not have been exactly extra-terrestrial, but more like ultra-terrestrial as more esoteric researchers offered.


And these esoteric studies were actually providing a lot more physical proof than the second generation's hypotheses. He broke this down into three categories:

- 1) Abductions
- 2) Animal mutilations
- 3) Crop circles

To add these elements to the old efforts about Roswell as just a government cover-up, in which only the government and the Army Air Forces knew anything about the events of July 1947, and as

researcher Tom Carey told David in 2006, "if it isn't July '47 it isn't Roswell", opens up the field all over again.

Cattle and horse and deer mutilations have been prevalent in the New Mexico and Colorado area from the beginning, as Linda Moulton Howe has pioneered the research as a prominent 2nd generationer, who's always advanced further into a



broader third generation analysis. Ranchers like Mac Brazel complained from the beginning about the AAF's insensitive treatment of their cattle and sheep, and many animals were discoloured and killed in bizarre ways by the atomic bomb tests at nearby White Sands Proving Grounds. This is a wide open field of historical research that may well provide a host of new clues about the Roswell incident's).

Local Apaches and Cheyenne's have always contended the crop circles seen in England and all over the world greatly resemble their prehistoric petroglyphs on nearby canyons in the Capitan Mountains, and they say the rock art was drawn and carved by spirits and gods who could well be mistaken or replaced by the modern terminology about aliens.

Just this year a stone with the exact geometric pattern of a crop circle was found in New Mexico, causing quite a furore and puzzlement among Roswell researchers.

By the 90s, David was ready to go back to the 40s before he was born, thanks to decades of research, ceremonies with Indians, sessions with psychics, and memories of many hours of conversations with his mother and father. He was confident he had found a realistic way to remember and reconstruct what really happened at Roswell, and, even more challenging, to see it from the point of view of the Enemies! For the great question that almost every earlier researcher and journalist always ended up asking, was, "Who are They? Where do they come from? What do they want?" And none of them seemed to have an answer beyond conjecture or religion or politics.

"They" loved World War Two. The unspeakable atrocities that H.G. Wells had written about so perceptively 50 years before, about unearthly monsters using extra-natural machines for murder and destruction beyond belief, were becoming truer than the worst villains could imagine.

Only these creatures were apparently

human, regardless of nationality or race or religion or gender. Anthropologists called them "killer apes" in archaeological discoveries in Africa and Persia, but those hominids became what science fiction writers were calling humanoids, and mystics had always called devils. Scientists in German death camps were experimenting with mutations and vicious hybridization, while epidemics of new viruses and bacteria continued to sweep the planet as never before.

But Lieutenant Jack Seals only knew Them as irrational nightmares, he told his fiancée Kay O'Brien in New Mexico, who told her children what he said years later.

Safely away from the killing fields of Nanking and Dresden, they thought, secrets were kept from each other, about his former pregnant wife, and the top-secret Bombs of mass destruction he carried in the hold of his B-29. And Kay didn't tell him her father was in the Mental Hospital in Pueblo, Colorado and had to be given a brain-destroying lobotomy operation as barbaric as anything in Auschwitz. She was afraid he'd think she was crazy too, and he was afraid his unfaithfulness and profligacy with women would jeopardize his career and a respectable marriage to a good Catholic girl.

She summed up their mutual nightmares by telling David in the 90s, after Jack died, when David asked about their marriage, "It was lousy from the beginning. You kids never knew." She kept it secret, you see. It was too terrible to talk about - about what really happened to a marriage that had the same problems and strengths of a lot of other marriages.

But there was more, a lot more, that came out in the terrible therapy sessions she had to go through in detoxification confinements at Fitzsimons Army Hospital and Mercy Hospital in Denver.

"They" took her and her husband and new born baby boy - who arrived mysteriously, somehow, from some other woman?! - in the midst of dark flying battles, at night, in the town, and out in

the desert. The doctors thought it might have been the horrors of her father's psychosurgeries that haunted her, and confused her, in her mind, in the secretive wedding night of a young Catholic virgin from a quiet little Arizona town, but she always insisted to them in therapy sessions over several years that they weren't dreams or nightmares. She told her daughter Jacque she had been very much awake when the three of them were taken into "a black place somewhere."

David couldn't believe it. No one could. In his case it was far too close to his own memories of a black energy when he was 20 years old and thought he was dying.

And it wasn't the only isolated case set in Roswell in those years. Others spoke to researchers about Military Police coming to their homes threatening to kill everyone in the family if they talked about the strange "Discs" captured outside of town. They told terrified children they'd be buried in the desert and never found again. They were just as terrifying as anyone's worst nightmares.

The years went by and Jack and Kay had more children, but the monsters came in their house again in Japan in 1956 and killed their firstborn daughter Kathy, a pretty blonde child of 4 years.

Kay saw them take her! David heard them in the house. They lived on a site where Jack's 509th Bomb Group had firebombed thousands of Japanese civilians in March 1945 as part of the savagery of the Worlds at War.



# THE STRANGE SAGA OF PAUL BENNEWITZ AND THE UNDERGROUND "ALIEN" BASE AT DULCE

A look at the book from Global Communications: "Underground Alien Bio Lab At Dulce: The Bennewitz UFO Papers"

The story of Paul Bennewitz is one of the sadder ones in all of Ufology. He seems to have been a victim from the very beginning, though he was not victimized by the aliens he came to believe in but rather the shadowy finagling of a government to whom he mistakenly gave his trust.





Bennewitz's experience, as related in a book on his struggle called "Underground Alien Bio Lab at Dulce: The Bennewitz UFO Papers," by Timothy Green Beckley and Christa Tilton, started in 1979. The twisted trail that is the story of Bennewitz took many bizarre turns on its path to UFO and conspiracy theory legend. One of the more mysterious places it led to is the tiny New Mexico town of Dulce, located not far from the Four Corners region of the American Southwest. For my own contribution to the abovementioned book, I spoke to some researchers about the strange rumours continually floating around Dulce, which together form one of the most interesting enigmas of the present age.

Perhaps the most vocal and visible expert on the Dulce mysteries is Norio Hayakawa, who has written many articles on the subject and appeared numerous times on radio and television programs dealing with the town.

"Dulce, New Mexico," Hayakawa said, "is a location filled with

mysteries that are still ongoing. I believe it is far more interesting than Roswell. Yes, Roswell was significant in that it is the alleged location of the crash of extra-terrestrial vehicles in 1947, but, you know, that was it. But Dulce is something different. It is an ongoing thing that is taking place.



"Not only that," Hayakawa continued, "but Dulce has the highest percentage per population of UFO sightings. This is a fact. Almost the entire town of Dulce, which has a population of about 2,600 now, almost the entire population has experienced a sighting of strange objects in the past 30 years. This is the highest percentage of any community in the United States."

But back to Bennewitz. The story goes that Bennewitz was a scientist living near Kirtland Air Force Base in Albuquerque, New Mexico. In 1979, he began to observe the flights of mysterious objects from his home, which was also adjacent to the Monzano Storage Area, the country's largest underground nuclear storage facility, as well as the Coyote Canyon Test Range.

"Albuquerque is very significant," Hayakawa said, "because it is where German scientists were first transferred in 1945, immediately after World War II, through the Operation Paperclip Program in which the U.S. brought into the country not only scientists from Germany but also many skilled intelligence officers."

Bennewitz began to film and attempt to report on the strange aerial activity he was witnessing, which immediately drew the interest of the government. One theory is that the bewildered scientist was seeing test flights of what are called "UAVs," or Unmanned Aerial Vehicles, pilot-less aircraft that are remotely controlled either on the ground or programmed by on-board computer systems. Whatever the secret flights involved, the

government did not want Bennewitz to know the truth.


Apparently, so the story goes, the government brainwashed Bennewitz into believing that he was witnessing a flight of alien discs over Kirtland Air Force Base. Bennewitz received a message somehow, either by radio or over his computer, saying that there is a secret base 150 miles north of Albuquerque in the mountains. Bennewitz was provided with the exact coordinates of this alien base, which of course turned out to be Dulce.

Bennewitz was never able to prove either the existence of aliens over Kirtland or the government's manipulations of his attempt to document the mysterious overflights. He sank deeper and deeper into an increasingly paranoid frame of mind, unable to cope with the bizarre scenario in which he had been en-

snared. In the years before his death in 2003, he corresponded with a woman named Christa Tilton, an alien abductee who was conducting research into UFOs in an attempt to understand her own experiences with what she felt may have been government agents posing as extra-terrestrials. A reprint of her manuscript about her dealings with Bennewitz is included herein, as well as photocopies of newspaper articles that dealt with Bennewitz and other witnesses to the strange craft. The book also reproduces letters exchanged with local law enforcement officials, who totally pooh-poohed any inquiries into the alien rumours around Dulce.

It all coalesces into a very complicated story that leaves one with more questions than answers, but Tilton and the other

writers do their utmost to bring some order to the general chaos. For instance, the book offers a lengthy interview with Thomas Costello, who claims to have been employed as a security guard at an underground facility in Dulce. Costello talks at length about interacting with aliens far below the surface and some of the protocols the humans and aliens were required to observe. Costello would sometimes be forced to intervene if a human wandered out of the zones where earthlings were permitted and had to try to smooth things over when an alien felt a human had crossed some kind of agreed upon line.

The interview with Costello, conducted by a writer named Bruce Walton (who also appears under the pseudonym Branton), is fraught with the kind of detailed information about day-to-day human and alien interaction that would seem to be very difficult to conjure out of nothing. Costello died about a year after the interview was conducted, a questionable case of suicide.

In addition, the book includes a report by Dr. Michael Salla in which he attempts to understand the Bennewitz/Dulce story based on primary sources as opposed to second-hand information

lieve?" Two different government disinformation agents, Richard Doty and William Moore, have both publicly confessed on more than one occasion to feeding disinformation to Bennewitz designed to throw him off the scent of what he had uncovered and documented about Kirtland Air Force Base and Dulce. As stated previously, Bennewitz began to grow increasingly paranoid as a result of their efforts at brainwashing him.

Writer Leslie Gunter contributes a report on Bennewitz to the book in which she firmly declares, "Still, Paul Bennewitz was not a complete nut. The signals he was receiving were real signals and Doty says the National Security Agency, who had their own offices at the base, were doing the sending and receiving. Doty was eventually replaced by NSA agents who wanted to make sure Bennewitz discredited himself by spreading wild stories about UFOs. They also wanted to keep an eye on him to make sure that he wasn't sharing his method of intercepting these signals with Soviet spies posing as UFO enthusiasts."

The pattern of deception extended to the cattle mutilations

and hearsay.

"Was Bennewitz just an overzealous UFO researcher," Salla asks, "that accidentally tapped into highly classified Air Force research and development projects? Or was he an electronics genius who single-handedly uncovered the existence of a joint U.S. government/ET underground base where ETs conducted gross human rights violations on abducted civilians? Seeking clear answers to these questions has spurred a number of books, articles and internet websites. A more scholarly effort of analysing the primary source material available on Dulce is needed to help answer key questions about the alleged base at Dulce."

And just what would that primary source material be? Salla said he started by reviewing whistle-blower testimonies that would seem to support Bennewitz as well as analysing current government whistle-blower protection laws. The long and tangled path was not made much clearer, but at least a sensible effort to solve the mystery in real world terms was underway.

There is no easy way to answer the question of "Who can we be-

lieve?" around Dulce, which the NSA wanted Bennewitz to continue to blame on the alien presence in the area. They also installed some fake air shafts in Dulce that Bennewitz was intended to believe served the underground base below. Sorting through the lies and manipulation, as Dr. Salla seeks to do, would seem a daunting task to say the least.

"In 1988," Gunter writes, "after eight years of constant stress and lack of sleep, Paul Bennewitz had to be taken to a mental hospital. His paranoia had reached an all-time high and he had pretty much barricaded himself in his home. He was hardly eating or sleeping and was sure aliens were coming into his home late at night and injecting him with strange chemicals."

Gunter credits Bennewitz with being the first to state that the alien abductors were inserting implants into their abductees, though Bennewitz felt the implants were some method of mind control as opposed to the more popular theory that they serve as a kind of tracking device that keeps the whereabouts of abductees easy to locate. Bennewitz did show others the needle marks left behind after the alleged alien injections, but it was never certain

whether the marks were self-inflicted or were in fact made in the way he claimed.

But leaving aside the story of Bennewitz's personal struggles, his revelations about the underground base at Dulce were nothing short of spectacular. The rumours that have circulated since then are full of nightmare scenarios like huge vats of human and animal body parts used in genetic experiments, perhaps in further efforts to create an alien-human hybrid species or an even stranger chimera that is part human and part animal. One expert says the government and the aliens may be working to create a "perfect soldier," one that is capable of fearlessness and obedience beyond that of the normal GI grunt. There is the case of a female abductee who claimed that she was in one of the lower sections of Dulce when an alien walked right through the wall and raped her. That kind of forced copulation may also be a component of the genetics experimentation said to take place in Dulce, the goal being to impregnate the human female with an alien seed and see what is produced, a scenario already familiar from other stories of

penetration into the American beef supply, which may account for some of the cattle mutilations in the area. The secrecy could have something to do with keeping the mad cow problem from panicking an already jittery public. They may also be using cattle to determine how much the ground was penetrated by nuclear fallout following the atomic testing in the last century.

When asked about the "alien stuff," Birnes replied, "Quite frankly, I can understand the alien hypothesis. I really do believe that there are areas where aliens and humans are working together, such as Area 51 and S-4. But whether Dulce is indeed that kind of base or not, everything we've seen – when you talk to Norio Hayakawa, when you talk to Gabe Valdez, a New Mexico state trooper, they really discount the alien connection and talk more about the New World Order. But I mean, the base is top secret, and there are serious things happening at the base. But whether it's because of aliens or because the aliens are a very convenient cover for even more dastardly things going on there – that I can't tell you."



While Birnes obviously has his doubts about an alien presence in Dulce, he did relate an interesting story about what has come to be called the "Firefight at Dulce."

"The story goes that all the way back in the 1980s," he said, "the extra-terrestrials were giving a lecture to some scientists. In that demonstration, a lot of the scientists were getting sick because of what the aliens were doing. So some of our military guards, who were prohibited from entering the area and prohibited from carrying any kind of weapons into that area, suddenly burst in to protect the scientists.

"And the aliens reacted," Birnes continued, "by basically turning their weapons on the security guards, killing them. Some aliens were killed and some scientists were killed. And supposedly we all worked very hard to try to patch it together so there wouldn't be any more incidents like that."

alien abduction.

For my part of the book, I also spoke to Bill Birnes, the former publisher of the now-defunct "UFO Magazine" and the team leader on the also defunct History Channel program "UFO Hunters." Birnes said that one possibility about what's happening at Dulce may be experiments with various virulent diseases and certain kinds of bacteria. Most of the land there is owned by the government, specifically the Bureau of Land Management, and the base may also lease some of the land from the nearby Indian reservation.

The government could be researching mad cow disease and its

Which brings us back to Paul Bennewitz. Was he just another casualty in a war zone of alien and government conflict? Did he cross some line of knowing that upset the powers that be, again powers that are both human and alien? While these questions cannot presently be answered, and may in fact never be answered, reading "Underground Alien Bio Lab At Dulce: The Bennewitz UFO Papers" will at least bring the curious reader up to speed on the ongoing discussion and the seemingly unending tug of war about the truth. Whether we're dealing with human beings and/or an alien contingent, they all seem to be playing this game for keeps.


### Ron Halliday






## CHAPTER 20: GENETIC WARFARE

Let us launch our minds out of the box and consider something I like to call Genetic Warfare. In order to do so, we will need to step back, far back from the personal point of view with which we normally view the world. We are going to step out of the box and consider a form of warfare which is eternal, unavoidable, utterly ruthless, unceasing and always to the death. To do so efficiently, we will imagine watching this war over a grand scale of time, with years and millennia sliding rapidly past.

We all like to think our lives are important—and they are! They are important not only to ourselves but also to our families, friends and associates and in many other ways we need not list here. But stepping back and watching the sweep of history pass by on a grand scale, we can see that any individual life is extremely unlikely to matter much on a scale of ten million or a hundred million years. Not that it can't happen—it can and occasionally does, individuals do sometimes come along who change the world forever...but lives like those on a scale like this are very rare indeed. If you're Genghis Khan, you'll make the list. If you're a dentist or an interior designer (or an author like me) well, it's just not going to happen. A million years from now nobody will know we ever existed at all...and nobody will care, either. That, I suppose, is how it should be and how it must be. It is in any case an inevitable and unavoidable fact—so let's deal with it on its own terms. And so out of the box we go...

On a scale of a million years the value and importance of the individual life rapidly fades away. Over tens and hundreds of millions of years, it is virtually nothing in the big scale of things.

If the individual life is indistinguishable from a billion other lives as the uncounted ages pass, what then *is* important over the vast stretches of evolutionary time scales?

The only thing which really matters on time scales like these is DNA. Genetics. Reproduction. Because your DNA is at war with every other set of DNA in the known universe and it always will be. What that means in practical terms is this: the only important thing we will ever do in our lives on this time scale is reproduce. The most successful DNA is always in the long run the DNA which produces the highest number of viable offspring and sends them forth into the world to copy the genetic information by producing yet more healthy offspring. If you

don't have children—for any reason—your unique individual genetic code, your DNA, will be lost forever when you die. Your DNA will vanish from the genetic pool and will have failed to perform its one over-riding purpose. It was not successful and it won't be seen again.

Consider the Black Widow spider. The only purpose it has in the entire world is to attempt to cover the surface of planet Earth with black widow spiders. Nothing else it does matters, as long as it is able to keep reproducing for as long as it possibly can. With luck, maybe it can end up making a million copies of itself, a million Black Widows which could in theory each go out and produce a million more copies of the DNA, each of which would in turn bring forth a million more in a cycle which is theoretically infinite and which, if not interrupted, would in short order actually cover the face of the Earth with Black Widow spiders.

Fortunately, they don't all have a million each and some get stepped on before they can lay any eggs at all. But the point is the same as far as the spider is concerned. Its only job is to either fertilize as many females as possible (usually that number is "one", for these particular males—they're not called Black Widows for nothing!) or to lay as many eggs as possible during its lifetime.

As long as the genetic information is copied and spread to new generations of spiders, it has fulfilled its only truly important function. Sending its own DNA forward in time helps its kind survive and prosper over the long term in a way nothing else ever could. It is, in a very real sense, the only form of immortal-

ity or eternal life available to a flesh-and-blood organism.

It is the same way--always and forever--with each and every living organism on the planet. A rabbit's primary evolutionary duty is to have as many baby rabbits as it can, attempting in its own way to cover the entire world with rabbits and sending its own unique genetic markers into the future, another generation of itself which will continue to do battle with all competing DNA types and attempt to once again successfully reproduce and carry on the genetic line. The hawk which catches it will try to cover the world with hawks. A flea will try to cover it with fleas. And so on.

This eternal struggle for life and dominance and the continuation of a species is by no means limited to just animals. Plants, too, do battle in a never-ending war of domination and conquest waged against every other plant they encounter. They will compete for sunshine, soil and water. They will wrap themselves around their competitor's trunk as they grow and attempt to choke the life out of it and so gain all that precious sunshine and topsoil for their own exclusive use. They will try to grow taller than the plants around them, in order to be able to utilize the maximum amount of sunlight possible (while at the same time denying it to the competition). They will each produce a multitude of seeds, attempting to cover the world with their offspring.

If dandelions can find a way to take over your yard, they will. If cedar can find a way to push Douglas fir off of a hillside or out of an area and take it over, it surely and inevitably will do so. Such is the nature of unceasing genetic warfare and of the eternal dominance dance of heredity, succession and DNA.

In modern society, medical technology and living conditions are such that most people can be expected to successfully reproduce at some point. This has the effect over the long term of weakening the gene pool because we make a practice of feeding those who cannot feed themselves, providing shelter and food to those who do not have it, giving them free medical care when necessary, etc. Survival of the fittest does not really apply in that sense because for the most part *everybody* can have kids regardless of their fitness, intelligence or physical prowess.

How, then, do various genetic lines compete in a world where the weak are artificially protected and even encouraged to reproduce?

Money, power and influence. Opportunities afforded to your genetic line which are denied to others. The wealthy attend the finest schools and universities, live in the finest homes on the best land, know all the right people, grease all the right palms and provide their offspring with virtual assurance of success, prosperity and eventual wealth themselves while a night clerk at a mini-mart struggles just to pay her power bill and keep a little gas in her car. When we look beyond the superficial and step backward, we can see that this is nothing but another form of genetic warfare taking place—just as it always has and always will.

If you want to fulfill your one and only primary duty to the eons, then, and if you want to succeed in the only thing which will matter a thousand years from now...get rich, very rich, by any means necessary. And have as many children as possible.

The most successful human DNA in history, by the way, belonged to Genghis Khan. By conquering and raping his way across most of the known world at the time, it is estimated that

8% of the male population across a huge part of Eurasia carries his DNA and that one in every two hundred men worldwide at the present time are genetically descended from him! His methods, though brutal and socially repugnant, were nevertheless tremendously effective in terms of carrying out his hereditary duty to his unique genetic footprint—in fact, nobody else in human history even comes close to this level of effectiveness.

Now we will step backward even further, to the point where Earth itself is too small to even be seen and our sun is just a tiny point of light in a sky filled with hundreds of billions of suns. All across this galaxy, on each and every one of the surely billions of worlds which support some form of life, this dance of death and succession proceeds apace and without end. Predators, prey, empires and forest fires, it continues always across each of those other worlds just as it does on our own.

It is nothing less than an eternal interstellar genetic war. There are intelligent beings on many of those worlds who have developed the means to travel rapidly and efficiently between the stars. They have been expanding outward, spreading their genetics and their racial DNA imprint to other worlds and other realities. Just like the Black Widow spider, their over-riding and imperative racial duty when considered in terms of the vast scope of passing eons, is to try to cover not just one world this time, but every habitable world in the entire galaxy with copies of themselves and thus be crowned King of the Hill and the ultimate victor in a genetic war which due to the nature of DNA itself can never be avoided or settled by any type of negotiations.

Now let's step back into the box for a minute and think about all that. The first thing which had better occur to us is this: extra-terrestrials of many dozens of races and types are already known to either visit this world occasionally or to inhabit it permanently even as we speak. And what is their goal? The same goal any other DNA receptacle would have, the same one you or I would have if we were in their place. It's to try to cover the entire face of the planet with copies of themselves and to do eternal battle with any other forms of DNA which resist their onslaught or present a danger to them in some way by eliminating, enslaving or consuming it. Think about THAT for a minute, if you will!

Among such a vast and diverse group of interstellar races as we already know exists—and there are without question many more intelligent races scattered throughout this galaxy of which we are still unaware, surely many times more than our scant knowledge at present allows us to have come across at this earliest stage of human space travel—all races and groups will not always get along. They will have disagreements, they will engage in competition for resources and for dominance and control of desirable uninhabited worlds by their own kind, their own genetic lines.

It is an established fact that interstellar warfare has and does take place between various factions of our ET visitors. There have been a number of historical reports of large numbers of people witnessing wars in the sky, chariots of fire blasting each other apart in our own atmosphere. Such violence, when it occurs, is by no means limited to our own little world—it takes place in any and all areas of conflict just as it does here. It is even said that there are two ET groups which have been waging constant war against each other for over a billion years.

When the proximate causes and intrigues of such interstellar conflicts are stripped away and we step back once again and

view the situation through the span of eons, it becomes quite clear that what we are looking at is one more example of genetic warfare in action, this time on an interplanetary and interstellar scale. Everybody out there is, in their own way and using their own methods, instinctively attempting to conquer not just single worlds but the whole galaxy by covering it with copies of its own DNA. The harsh reality of the bottom line is this: if somebody else beats them to it, they will lose the genetic sweepstakes by being the *second-to-the-last* race left standing. Clearly that is a position nobody would wish to occupy and one which nobody would allow to occur if they had the power to stop it from happening.

Now we are constantly told about friendly extra-terrestrial races, visitors who have come here only to aid and assist us in our development as a people. I do not doubt that friendly and helpful extra-terrestrials exist—there are too many reliable witnesses to think otherwise. But we must keep in mind that for all their friendliness they, too, have their limitations.

Apparently some among us believe that all of this assistance they want to give us will be undertaken at their own expense utilizing their people, resources, time and energy in a purely philanthropic mission to aid a human race which freely admits it is violent, brutal, dishonest, manipulative, scheming, cruel, warlike, bigoted, greedy, selfish, vain and untrustworthy. Ask yourself: would you spend your money, time and energy to help a race which fits that profile?

Would you send your sons and daughters forth into the galaxy to a faraway world in order to assist a race of killer apes who would surely declare war on your own civilization and conquer it if they had the ability to do so? What would motivate you to make a decision like that? If you chose to assist them, would you not have an ulterior motive for doing so, some reason that assisting them would in some way be profitable or helpful to you rather than be nothing but a large drain of your resources and manpower?

Why should we presume that the so-called “friendly” ET’s do not have motives for helping us that we know nothing about and which do not involve benefiting humanity but instead are intended to benefit the ET races in question? I would never make such a presumption and you shouldn’t either.

Going by our own history, the odds that they are spending their resources purely for our benefit without intending to somehow be reimbursed or emerge with a profit or advantage of some kind are very small indeed. It is a bet that only a fool would take.

In the long term, it would seem that they will ultimately be engaging in genetic warfare no matter where they go or what they do, as will we. There is no way to avoid it. Without the fact of genetic warfare, it could easily be said that life itself has no objective purpose and no long-term value or worth.

No sane and rational race or group would ever sacrifice its own genetic code for the benefit of the genetic code possessed by a race from another world. To do so would amount to racial suicide, voluntary consignment to oblivion. Such a thing is unthinkable. It is also out of the question, because the over-riding instinct of any life form must be reproduction of its own DNA—even if an alien race should consciously make the decision to do such a thing, the DNA itself would ultimately override that choice and ensure that breeding and reproduction continued one way or another.

Whether or not we realize that we are engaged in eternal genetic warfare against not only our own kind but all other DNA in existence, our DNA at a cellular level realizes it very well indeed. It has no intention of losing that war and will do anything within its power to make sure it does not, regardless of what our own personal intentions might be.

I often make the point that for all the extra-terrestrials who claim to be our friends and who say they want only to assist us, such assistance to this point has not resulted in anything we can actually notice or identify. The alleged assistance we have been given could easily be thought to be nothing but a series of high-minded diatribes written by humans themselves with no outside assistance of any kind.

In practical terms, if one were to take the position that they have so far not helped us in any way that actually matters, it would be quite difficult to argue against that statement. If one were to say that as best we can tell they have in fact not helped us in any way at all up to this point, there is no rebuttal argument which can be made because there is no way to identify what that help may have been and therefore there is no reason to think any help was really given.

There will surely be many who would point out that such a viewpoint is jaded and I will not disagree with them. I do, however, think it is fair to say that the viewpoint—jaded though it may be—is also accurate. I would also mention that I have never yet met anyone who could demonstrate that it is incorrect other than by presenting an argument which consists entirely of wishful thinking and personal hopes being projected onto a reality which does not support them.

What if helping us would result in an attack by the Reptilian/Grey consortium against their own home world and possibly result in its destruction? If that is the case, no help will be forthcoming no matter how much they might wish to assist us. They can be expected to do exactly the same thing we would do under such conditions: withhold assistance and thereby protect our own interests, which is another way of saying that our top priority would be to ensure the safety of our own DNA and all other considerations would be secondary to that one.

Even if that is not the case, even if they can safely help us progress and choose to do so, the eternal drumbeat of genetic warfare will never cease and dominance will always be its only purpose. If at some point in the future we find ourselves in a situation of disagreement or conflict with even the friendliest of extra-terrestrial races, if it comes down to the choice of them or us... they will most assuredly not choose “us”. Their DNA itself will make very sure of that.

This long-term perspective and the fact that it is inevitable, unceasing and impossible to avoid should give us ample reason to keep our guard up at all times and never intentionally allow ourselves to be placed in a position where our existence is in the hands of extra-terrestrials rather than ourselves.

It may well be impossible to avoid ending up in such a position—in fact we may very well occupy it at this very moment. If so, it gives us even more reason to be aware that if the race or races which hold our fate in their hands ever decides it has to choose between its own interests and our survival... that will be the day we lose the genetic war for good.

# UFO PILOTS - ARE THEY HUMAN?

For over 30 years, I have searched for the possible source of UFO occupants. What might their origin be? I am firmly convinced that some UFO occupants are of extra-terrestrial origin, be they from inside the Solar System, perhaps Europa or Titan, or outside the Solar System.

Of course it seems most likely they are from distant planets circling distant stars. I have also researched the possibility that some UFO occupants originate in dark matter.

However, another intriguing possibility arises: It involves the concept of the probable singularity between humans and artificial intelligence in the future. Could they be Future Humans with the enhancements of artificial intelligence?

(I capitalize "Future Humans" because I see them as a separate tribe or species from us, and yet they are the humans of their time).

I want to disclose that when I was four years old, during an encounter with UFO occupants, I was told, "We are from your future." I remember this message as clearly. It is in my conscious mind and always has been; this message is not a result of channelling or hypnotic regression.

In the spiritual aspect of my work, I have had it confirmed that some of my messages are from Future Humans; I do, however, keep this spiritual aspect of my work separate from my UFO and scientific research.

We are told that by 2045, humankind will join with artificial intelligence; then artificial intelligence will continue to expand faster than organic human intelligence.

The moment of Singularity will be arguably the most important event in human history, which might be why it is usually capitalized.

In researching the Future Human/UFO theory, two problems are always presented:

Problem #1:

Humans are a long way from being advanced enough (intelligent enough), to develop time travel.

It might involve creating worm holes, or warping space or some quantum manipulation. After all, today we are still debating the basics of quantum mechanics.

Problem Solved: However, linked into computer intelligence, we can perceive that we humans just might figure out how to traverse time.

It might be a matter of sending one's mind into time rather than one's body, or it might mean boarding a silver star ship and warping (folding) space.

Whatever the specifics, enhanced intelligence, probably through quantum computers should open the time travel doors! Quantum computers exist now but their current primitive state is only the beginning.

Problem #2: If traveling time, backward or forward, means warping space or other incredible means, then humans will not be able to stand the radiation, g-forces, and other hardships.

In fact, humans might not be able to go to space more than they already have, due to the high radiation factor. So those UFO occupants just cannot be Future Humans, so says the argument.

Problem Solved: Artificial intelligence will make us nearly

immortal. Our mind can be upgraded at any time; freshly injected nanobots will also knock out cancer, Alzheimer's, ALS, Parkinson's and similar diseases.

Any organ will soon be replaceable. We will fast become a race of androids, part organic, part artificial. And so, of course we will be able to live through the radiation and other rigors of space. Galaxy, here we come!

There is a lot of evidence that some UFO occupants are Future Humans. For one thing, UFO occupants are obviously very interested in Earth and may well have been here for thousands of years.

They have certainly been here since 1947, mostly observing, turning off and on nuclear missile codes, playing chase with the military, capturing a few humans in a "catch and release" program, taking human tissue samples, and taking environmental samples.

They have never attacked us, one army to another. In fact, it seems they patrol our skies through some hidden agenda to protect Earth.

Future Humans should have control of Earth skies. Perhaps they keep less friendly ET races from taking us over? Who would be concerned about Earth herself – humans or ETs?

In 1952, the year of my first encounter aboard a vessel with a man who said he was a Future Human, there was also a UFO landing five miles up the road from my farm where my encounter took place.

A farmer was gathering hay when a saucer landed beside the creek, two dwarf-size humans got out and dipped a vessel into the creek, filled it, then walked back to their saucer and took off.

This UFO landing was kept a secret for over 60 years because the farmer feared derision from townspeople. I found out about it through his elderly cousin after the farmer died.

Personal knowledge like this, including the tissue sample which was taken from me, plus over 30 years of research in the UFO field, has convinced me that some UFOs are manned by humans from some other time. This time might be from AFTER a nuclear holocaust.

If a few humans retain technology and continue to develop it, it is apparent that they would then go back in time and warn us. They would also take healthy human tissue samples and delve into our genetics. Their own future might even depend on us "pre-nuclear."

And yes, our own physical structure after a nuclear war might begin to look like those emaciated, grey/white ETs; there would be both radiation mutation and our reliance on artificial intelligence would shrink muscle structure anyway.

But let's not assume there is to be nuclear war, but simply continue with the idea that we do exist as a species in the future.

That's potentially good news!

"Future" of course becomes meaningless. Once we have travel time, we can go back to when-ever we wish. Humans would become citizens of "no-time" and "every-time in history."

Human time travellers are the ultimate practical argument because true ETs would have to have somehow traversed the incredible distances and barriers like super-high radiation in outer space, then discovered tiny Earth and decided to hang around Earth for probably millennia, or at least from 1947.

There is that enticing idea with some evidence that "they" have been here since humans emerged on Earth (whoever "they" is), so if the visitors are true ETs, they must have had the ability to travel the vast distances in space for millions of years. This gives rise to the possibility that Earth is a colony of ETs.

But what if it is a human colony? Well, that's what we are!

The human time traveller concept presents a surprisingly practical picture. Humans are cover Mother Earth in every layer of time which is laid down. First, the prehistoric time-layer is still right here, in the same exact spot. To the cave men, it was the Eternal Now, just as it is to us today. We never are in the past, we never are in the future, and we only are in "the now."

So, the Eternal Now is a crowded place! The next layer which is laid down upon this infinite moment in time, is the layer of ancient times as humankind began to use its intelligence to expand and invent; curiosity and survival drove us on, and drives us on even today.

What if, with advanced (most likely) quantum technology, humans in the future find a way to drill down through those layers of time, never needing to travel the vast distances of space, and always with inherent passion and "ownership" of their Mother Earth.

It is more than an interest; future humans with quantum equipment feel they have the right to Earth too.


Visualize this one spot - Planet Earth - with all her layers of human civilization, all layered on top of each other. Space does not separate us, only the small matter of time.





## THE CONCEPT BEHIND THE CONFERENCE

#### FOREWORD

Much has been made of Nigel's endeavour to bring this conference to the fore. Some good and some not so good. We at Outer Limits Magazine are happy to allow Nigel to express his reasons behind this conference and proud to be able to support Nigel in his endeavour to bring this significant conference to the fore. With less than a year to go to what should be one of the UK's premier UFO related events of 2017. Nigel deserves support from all aspects of ufology, in this endeavour, whether you think this is right or not! This is a bold step in to the future, this conference gives you a chance to get involved at the ground floor level.

I am proud of my reputation as being known as one of the 'old school' Ufologists still active in the investigation and research of UFOs. I will give my reasons for that soon, but I can assure the reader that this statement is not based on any ego-driven Self appraisal.

I am also appreciative that I am still able to be active within the subject at the age of 57 years and retain the ability to investigate UFOs in the same way that I did over 35 years ago when the phenomenon first became known to me.

I have seen a heck of a lot of changes within Ufology in that time. Some good, some not so good. I won't say some were really bad, as it is my own belief that I am sure somewhere down the line, even in those bad times, some good came out of the learning. However, the one solid thing that I have learnt myself by being involved for so long, is that the real problem that we all face within Ufology and how we go about investigating, researching and qualifying what UFOs may be, is down to the different approaches as human beings we all take and with that an underlying reluctance to accept new ideas and the ability to think outside of the norm.

This amazes me really, as the very essence of UFOs tells us all that the subject is anything but an aspect of the everyday normality for the majority of people on this planet.

To understand and appreciate where the concept of New Ufology comes from, I will have to take you back to the heady UFO days of the 1980s. This period was what some may call an 'exception' within the historic timeline of Ufology in the UK and elsewhere to some degree in the rest of the world. Here in the UK we had some major UFO incidents taking place during that and the preceding decade including the famous Rendlesham Forest landing, the Todmorden Adamski Mystery, the Cracoe Fell debacle, The Wyke Woods Flap, The Alan Godfrey Abduction, The Ilkley Moor Alien Photograph, to name a few. I also had my own personal UFO encounter in November 1980 in Wharfedale which led me to be actively involved in investigations for Jenny Randles' Northern UFO Network and as an Area Director of Investigations for BUFORA.

My initial written report sent to Jenny Randles (which later appeared in her book, 'The Pennine UFO Mystery' Granada Paperback 1983) about the strange events that took place after I saw an Orange Ball of Light over my home town of Otley, was included due to the thoroughness of my reporting and an eye for detail. This was simply born out of seeking the truth in what I found to be a puzzling mystery at that time, in the hope that I would someday find an answer to what had happened to me (and I found out in time, many others).

From that initial experience I travelled the length and breadth of Yorkshire seeking out and investigating UFO reports, forming my own local group and laying the foundations for what was to become the Independent UFO Network (IUN), still regarded to this day all over the world as being one of the truly groundbreaking UFO teams of its time which led to the foundations of modern Ufology.

At that time, up until about the mid 1980's I had been regarded by BUFORA and most of the regional UFO groups around the UK as a 'decent' investigator and was given many platforms to re-tell my own accounts of what have now become classic cases in certain circles. As mentioned then things began to change for me around 1986.

Amongst the literally thousands of UFO cases that I had investigated leading up to that time, there must have been quite a number (much more than the much repeated 5% and then later 10%) of all close encounters being of an inexplicable nature, even though I had been trained, had developed the awareness and honesty to explore each case with an open mind to search out the truth whether that be something misidentified or something we could not readily explain. I looked around me at that time and I could see what was happening. There were many investigators who had established a name for themselves as so called experts and the safest ground that they could tread was to 'never mention their own' personal thoughts as to what a very strange case may involve?

Safest ground was to talk about distant lights in the sky, it was 'OK' to mention UFO landing and ground traces, it was necessary to describe CE3's, but that's where the buck stopped. No serious UFOlogists would at that time, dare to venture into the 'out of the box' possibilities that were clearly staring them in the face. For at that time, to state that you thought this may have involved actual aliens from another world as the only explanation, was paramount to placing your head on the chopping block of permissible behaviour within the 'serious-minded' UFO community of investigators! We are talking of a time when most of the general public, many of whom still thought of UFOs as being more Sci-Fi than anything real, would shout out 'nutter!' in the presence of those who were willing to explain their own truths at a high cost to reputation and sometimes friendships, marriages and jobs.

It was at this time in the history of British Ufology, that (even

though I knew how other 'experts' would react) I decided to 'come out' so to speak. Not only had I had an experience with an Orange Ball of Light, but I was suddenly now telling people that 'it spoke to me' and not long after that, I was actually conversing through a psychic ability that came to me with that experience (as again has happened with thousands of other close encounter experiencers) with the 'aliens' behind the whole episode in my life.

Needless to say, the invitations to speak about my UFO investigations stopped coming in from most of the local and national groups, but sadder still was the fact that some of those 'expert' UFOlogists who had been previously happy to work alongside me and give high credit to my work in the field, were now the ones who were shouting 'nutter!' in my direction. This became a very difficult time for me, but I was brought up as a person who understood the value of truth, especially when things of a high strangeness continued to happen to myself and my immediate family, so I decided to keep true to my own path and accept what had happened and mainly worked on my own. I can say today, without a shadow of doubt, that I am so glad that I did for it has shown me (from the outside looking in, so to speak) just how Ufology has progressed.

During the 1990's and the advent of the internet UFO groups, it came as no surprise to me to see that there had been many people like myself all over the world who were now willing to explain their own feelings, explore new territories and above all be honest with themselves about their own UFO encounters.

This began the demise of the ridiculer's within the subject because it suddenly became so obvious that the subject (on a massive scale worldwide) had to include high-strangeness cases and that meant without question, real people were having very real interactions with something that the old-way Ufologists could not fit into their respectable science based boxes of possibility.

Unfortunately, the internet had a down-side too. It gave birth to the platform which was taken up by those who didn't really have any intention to seek out the truth concerning UFOs, but are happy to play around with the subject and place pseudo-UFO videos, cases and fake accounts in front of the world and claim them to be genuine. But a strange thing happened here. Although it soon became obvious (and to some degree it still happens I know) that the credibility of these people behind such pranks was brought into question and rightfully so, there were

very few cries of 'Nutter!' as in the previous decades. There had been a shift in human expectations concerning the reality of UFOs, so although most knew that these pranksters were doing a disservice to the subject by muddying the waters between what was genuine and not, it did not seem that outlandish to promote the visitation of non-human beings to this planet, no matter the container of that message.

Through the 1990's and the Naughties, I do believe that Ufology changed because our expectations as human beings changed. It was not that there were more CE3's and 4's, more Bedroom Visitations, or better access to more reliable equipment to monitor UFOs. It was because the human perception of what we had been dealing with all along had changed and evolved alongside our own body-spirit evolution as a species during that same time.

And this is where we find ourselves now in 2016. The Nutters! have left the room. Talking to anyone today who promotes themselves as a person who has undergone a close UFO experience leaves one without any doubt that they are very normal in the majority of cases and people who are above all else, brave. They are willing to tell their story no matter how similar people from yesterday were victimised and laughed at for doing so. They are all pioneers, taking Ufology forwards in a sensible yet enlightening way. There is absolutely nothing wrong with that at all!

Maybe I had been born in the wrong decade to have to have gone through these changes. I do not know the reasons for that for sure, but I do know that I would not change what happened if I had the chance to again. Back in 1986, I was given an insight into what was to come for Ufology in the present time and I was given a choice, to either join the respectable club and make a little money out of standing up on the speakers pedestal of major UFO organisations, retaining my reputation and staying close buddies with those 'experts' at the head of the game (as they thought they were back then) or to be honest with myself. I am so glad I chose the latter for in doing so, it opened up an amazing life in which I have seen evidence for UFO reality that leaves me convinced that we are not alone and never have been.

There are lots of 'buts' at the basis of New Ufology. Another is fundamental to the concept and comes out of the life-long experience

that I have just been explaining. That is the problem we have with accumulation of UFO cases and what we should really be doing with all of that massive amount of data? But, I hear some say, we need to keep logging experiences so that eventually we will have enough data for us to be able to see the picture in full. We still have several important pieces missing (which is obvious and has been for some time) and without keeping up the investigating and reporting of cases, we will never get to a point to see this.

Well, I agree and I disagree with this 'but'.

Think about how long the millions of UFOlogists all over the world, in every country, for decades over decades have been doing this? There must be, and is, a mountain upon mountains of data that shows one clear thing. People like you and me have been experiencing something so different to the things happening in everyday life, that it stands out and has common factors. Someone once said, 'it takes only one of those cases to be the real deal and we are dealing with something extra-ordinary'. How clear can that not be to us all?

Yet, to some in this subject, all that is required to remain 'a decent and science-based' UFOlogists is to carry on sifting through the data we already have in tons (and I literally mean 'tonnes') and keep adding to it in the same manner we always have done. Unfortunately, the one thing that this will show us after so long now, is that we will not reach any conclusively full picture as to what is actually going on using this method alone. If we could, then I am sure we would have done so by now.

So, it seems to most rational-minded thinking people, that we need to do something else. This is New Ufology; an approach that is not ignoring the important work that many Ufologists did back in the last few decades (and remember, I was amongst them too at that time) by investigating and reporting on that massive scale, but to look back with the data and think have we been missing something all along? What have we been leaving out of all of that data ?

The obvious thing, so startlingly obvious, is the fact that we ARE dealing with something that is not of a 'normal' human consequence or fits in with 'normal' rational human behaviour. In fact, what it does show us, is, that the 'Nutters' were right, even back then!

OK, so I am not saying we need a set of 'spaced out to the extremes' kind of people involved in New Ufology (even though I am sure some of the 'old school' would like that to be so because they feel uncomfortable in the knowledge that New Ufology could make sense?), but in a way, I am saying that, if you see what I mean? We need people who are brave enough to be honest about their experiences and to continue to tell it as it is, warts and all.

There is no room for the previous UFO snobbery in the way forward if we all want to reach out for those missing pieces of the picture. We need people who are able to keep one foot in the science-based investigatory and research world, yet another foot that dares to venture into the 'wonderment' of what this all means on a level of future expectation.

In a way, it is make your mind up time. Do you choose to move this subject on and dare to dream of new possibilities

which involve the actual realisation that we are dealing with a true unknown that is very different to ourselves and probably comes from elsewhere, or do we relax into the same old notion that all Ufology consists of is investigating cases, writing them up and then filing them away for prosperity? If it is the latter, I would suggest you take up train-spotting. You will have much more success in fulfilling your personal dreams....not that I am having a go at anyone who goes out train-spotting (I love trains too) but I am sure you can see the point I am making here.

So, how can New Ufology be different?

Apart from a very simple concept that has been with us as long as UFOs have been sighted, that when you witness something highly unusual you look for the highly unusual within the experience and that makes the whole episode 'unusual', we need to look for this aspect with 'new eyes'. I believe we are all able to do this and it involves just a couple of really easy to do things. Be honest about what is being related to you, be truthful and do not exaggerate facts, and if it seems that something is pointing to a high-strangeness event, follow it up at the site.

By doing this, you will soon discover that the 'phenomenon' that may have been related to you in a single case, is in fact sometimes repeated and others have witnessed it in the same way leading to further evidence that something 'real or unreal (as may be the case) is actually taking place at that locality. In the past, it was left to sporadic witnesses to UFO events over periods of time (even years) for this kind of picture to build up about the location where UFO interactions take place, but New Ufology says, 'hey, we now know this happens, lets get our butts out there to the site and monitor it properly'. Often, you will find by taking this approach, you gain evidence for something unusual happening there much more quickly and because it is the UFO investigator themselves that become witness to further happenings, then a higher level of evidence is built up for the case.

I mentioned how Ufology, good and bad, has evolved alongside our own expectations as human beings as to what, where from and who the UFOs are? One of the problems in the past is that many cases were explored from the purely science-based notion that everything about the phenomenon should be able to be realised with our five normal senses for it to be a true or real

event in any case? This has to change, for we now understand, and ironically it is science that is showing us this, that reality is much more complex than it was understood to be 35 years ago. The question of what is reality is at the heart of the UFO puzzle and I feel that should we continue to only use our five normal physical senses to investigate something that is obviously able to ignore many of the popular science based theories, then we really should be looking for answers with something we all have other than simply the eyes. That is intuition and feelings. Look on the internet today and see how many Ufologists actually are being drawn into other aspects of the paranormal, like Remote Viewing for example. RV is just one of the intuitive and psychic methods that has been used by science based methodology groups, the military and possibly secret government groups, in the recent decades in order to seek out hidden information that would be impossible with the five normal senses. The Russians were working with RV at the very time that British 'old school' Ufologists were calling those with supposed psychic abilities of a similar nature to RV, nutters! This must surely tell us all something.

New Ufology is a concept that has grown out of years of observation. It is not a new fad or anything that is meant to replace that which has gone before. It is, however, needed more than at any time since the dawn of modern Ufology, if we are to move with the times and our own evolution towards a better understanding of the truth regarding UFOs. New Ufology is about brave people, people who dare to dream, not in private, but openly with others who are committed to really and honestly learning about the reality of UFOs.

If this is not for you and sounds a little too outlandish a step forward, then I do understand. For you, I say just keep filing away those reports. The one good thing you will get out of that is a credible portfolio of interesting UFO cases which you will be able to repeatedly describe to the old school UFO conference goers. You will not, however have any more of an answer to provide to them than anyone had all those years before, even though there were thousands of such cases being filed away back then too.

One other 'but' is something that needs to be addressed by New Ufology. Today, on the conference circuits there are some so-called 'experiencers', who have very amazing and vivid stories to tell to their mass audiences, time after time. Many of these

people have no evidence to back up what they claim, whether it be being fathered by a Reptilian Being, meetings with Tall Beings, or acquiring so-called artefacts from UFOs. I would like to say that their own personal accounts would be enough to lend weight to their stories, but sadly we never get that and are mostly left with promises that this will be forthcoming or that they cannot provide such evidence for one reason or another. All we are ever offered by these people is a bucket of water full of holes. Anyone with such an amazing account to relate must know that their 'audiences' need clarification, but this has never stopped them from presenting something that could have been dreamed up on a cig packet one sunny afternoon. I am amazed not at their stories or the content within them, but the fact that they often times not, have not a shred of evidence to even say they were at the place or time when it happened! But, hey, who cares, the story sounds great and in any case, he wouldn't make anything up because he is a nice man and sends positive messages from his space friends to help us all.

How gullible can we be!

That is why New Ufology presents a way in which those who (I am absolutely sure of their sincerity in many cases) do undergo amazing and truly inexplicable experiences, a platform to relate what has happened with good evidence to back up their story. How can this good evidence come about...well quite simply really. Cross-referencing times, places and dates works well, showing examples of what you were doing at the time of the experience, genuine photos and videos, others that can account for your story, doctors notes to show you had a medical effect, lots and lots of other ways....but you get the point. A story without any kind of evidence is just that, a story, and those peddling these stories know that to be the case. New Ufology will demand some kind of evidence before these people are allowed a platform to relate their case



and if they are decent honest people, they will be happy to look for that evidence first so that they can use their experience as something to show the reality of it, other than a method to make money out of those wishing to learn more.

You see, New Ufology does not mean that you have to completely re-write the book. I hope that I have shown this here. I can say still today that I am just as able to go out and investigate a UFO case in as thorough, experienced and respectful way that I ever did in my days with BUFORA. Nothing has changed there at all for me. But, I feel lessons have been learned on my part and others too. For the last 30 years or so, I have retained that awareness to adapt the scientific basis within investigations, yet I have dared to dream of other blatantly obvious possibilities, putting my other hat on as a channeller, a psychic and

a dowser into practice alongside the traditional and the accepted. Why would I not do so if these possibilities are available to us? I hope many of you will think about this new direction built upon the old ways, built upon the bravery of those who stepped away from the acceptable when others could not.

I will be giving an appraisal of New Ufology at the National New Ufology Conference at High Bentham, Lancaster,, UK, in July 2017 alongside some of the country's top speakers.

# UK 9/11 Sightings

Sunday 9 September 2016, was a day of events in the UK. With the Outer Limits Editor attending the UFO Truth Conference, in Holmfirth, strange and unusual sightings were taking place close by near Leeds and in the English midlands city of Leicester.

Our first report from Colin Saunders outlines and includes images of a strange bat like craft (for want of a better word) moving over Leicester. Our second report comes in via Andi Ramsden's East Yorkshire UFO Hunters...Again a large craft moving through the skies over Yorkshire... the images we present are as presented to us at OLM...

It's been more than 17 years since my own close encounter with a flying triangle and over that period of time I have had many people come to me with their own reports of UFO encounters. Some of your readers may remember a previous article I wrote in this magazine regarding Triangular UFO's around the Hinckley area. I now have a new report that I would like to share with you which took place on 11/09/16 at 5.40 pm on the outskirts of Leicester.

Now coincidentally the report is from not only a good friend of mine (so I can vouch for his integrity) but also an ex-employee who was actually working for me around the time of my own UFO encounter.

Andrew Headley was out walking his dog and taking pictures of aeroplanes and contrails when he spotted this unusual looking object in the sky. Snapping 18 shots in total the best 12 are here for you to see this Bat like object yourself. Based on previous photo's the object (actually 2 objects) were estimated as being at 20,000 feet. Some remarkable pictures I'm sure you will agree and here in his own words is Andrews full statement as told to me personally this week.

"On the 11th September 2016 I was walking my dog in the Aylestone Meadows, an area of open countryside just outside of Leicester in the United Kingdom. I had my camera with me to catch a few shots of the local countryside which is a Nikon D5200 with a 70-300mm zoom lens.

At 5.38 pm I noticed a couple of low flying planes and put a telephoto lens on my camera to take a photo of them. About 1 minute later a shiny, stationary object caught my eye that looked crescent shape I estimated the object to be approximately at 20,000 feet based the other aircraft in the vicinity at the time. By the time I had taken my lens cap off (approximately 10-20 seconds later) the object appeared to be spinning at approximately one revolution a second in a very consistent movement. At this point I took my first photo.

Over the next minute and a half I took 18 photos. For all of this time the object seemed to remain in the same position

whilst still rotating at exactly the same rate.

At this point I noticed another unusual object that also was crescent shape and appeared to be at a similar altitude. It was a little distance from the other object and was travelling at great

speed towards it, I believe considerably faster than I have seen any planes fly. I aimed the camera towards the new object but it disappeared behind some cloud before I could get a photo and I lost sight of it.


At this point I looked to the location of the original object, which was still there and took a couple of photos. Seconds later the object moved rapidly towards the horizon in a steady, consistent path and was no longer visible after about 10 seconds. I think, but am not certain, that the last photo I took was just after the object started moving. I tried hard to locate the second object again but couldn't. I don't know if it could be relevant but I also took a few photos of low flying planes before and afterward in the same location."

When suddenly, something strange appeared in the sky, so



Maybe I'm paranoid, but I think it was time well spent when I made the tapes."

John Hanson: "The evidence of this book about UFOs per se is just in itself explosive in nature and speaks volumes! There is a colossal difference, in my opinion, between low grade UFO files declassified by the MOD as part of their release into the public sector over the last 20 years, and so many other reports which go back to the mid to the end of the last century, many of which I have investigated that will never see the light of day."


