
# ALIEN AUTOPTSY THE OBSERVER

## SPEAKS!

In 1995 London businessman Ray Santilli launched his controversial Alien Autopsy Film around the globe. Not surprisingly it caused a storm and it was probably the first 'UFO battle' fought out on the new fangled internet. As I was the first UFO researcher contacted by Santilli I was caught up in this battle. I'll not go into what Santilli claims as I have done so on many occasions. It took my 14 years to get to the bottom of it all and finally prove that the Alien Autopsy film was exactly what many people had claimed it was, a money-making scam. The rest as



they say is history.

There are however a few people who still believe that Ray Santilli is telling the truth and there was original (authentic) film.

One such gentleman in the UK is Colin Woolford. Colin and I disagree but we have remained on friendly terms. In January 2017 Colin provided me with the email address of one of the 'actors' in the film. This chap plays the 'doctor' or 'the observer' behind the glass in the Alien Autopsy Film and his name is Gareth Watson. Colin had contacted him but had no reply. I had met Gareth in Ray Santilli's office several times in 1995/96.

I would like to thank Colin Woolford for his cooperation with this and I contacted Gareth Watson on the email provided. Much to my surprise he responded.

What follows in a brief Q & A that took place between myself and Gareth Watson (GW) at the end of January 2017. Please make of it what you will.

**1: Tell us a little something about yourself. Who is Gareth**

**2 & 3: Stills from the 'tent footage'.**  
This was the film on VHS shown to Gareth Watson by Ray Santilli under the guise that it was 'authentic'. Unknown to Gareth this 'tent footage' was not authentic and was made by a chap called Keith Bateman in a barn in Bedfordshire.

**Watson, what do you do for a living, what part of the world do you live etc.**

GW: Previously managing director of Telstar and firefly entertainment! Consultant for home entertainment publishing and IP.

**2: When did you first meet Ray Santilli.**

GW: When I was working at Lumiere Pictures (with Gary Shoefield) 1994?

**3: I met you several times in Santilli's London office along with Gary Shoefield. What was your job there, in what capacity were you employed.**

GW: I was marketing manager and oversaw operations.

**4: When did you first learn that Ray Santilli & Gary Shoefield were planning to fake the alien autopsy film.**

GW: When at Mastervision. They called me into the office a few weeks before filming.

**5: Who was it that asked you to be an 'actor' in the fake film: i.e., the 'doctor' behind the glass.**


GW: Both

**6: When did you first meet Spyros Melaris.**

GW: Before the shoot I was introduced as he was involved with Ray Santilli and Gary Shoefield.

**7: Did Spyros Melaris tell you what the plans were for the film.**

GW: Ray Santilli and Gary Shoefield did.

**8: Once the alien autopsy film was made were you asked to remain silent regarding what you knew and your part in it.**

GW: I was.

**9: What did you make of the world wide TV coverage of the film and later the Ant & Dec movie.**

GW: Thought the movie was rubbish and I was never approached for my name to be used (it wasn't).

**10: Looking back now how do you view the fact that the hoax alien autopsy film made a lot of money for Santilli and co.**

GW: I made zero money and I was not on a generous salary by any means. Ray Santilli and Gary Shoefield made a lot of money

**11: Knowing what you know now if you could turn back the clock would you still have participated or would you have kept out of it all.**

GW: Kept out of it.

**12: Have you anything you would like to add about the alien autopsy film hoax that perhaps you have never shared with anyone before.**

GW: I was led to believe there was original footage of poor quality and this was "a recreation" (Santilli words) not a hoax

**13: Just to clarify things please. It is correct that you never saw any original film footage. At what point did you learn it was indeed a hoax.**

GW: I was shown by Ray Santilli and Gary Shoefield a vhs copy of very grainy poor quality footage of an alleged alien autopsy! They decided it was not of commercial value in its current state hence the "recreation"! So I left with impression that what I saw was the original footage! I have no idea where that is now or what Ray Santilli did with it.

**14: Gareth, was this the film you were shown (link to the tent footage provided).**

GW: That's the footage I am in as the observer I thought! The original footage was of very poor quality to the point I could have been looking at the Yeti.

**15: When did you realise that it was not a recreation but an outright hoax.**

GW: Well I know the footage was "passing off" on the "original" "unusable" "very ambiguous " footage. I was told this (legal ramifications?)

**16: That's great Gareth. I understand all that Santilli has said but when did you personally discover or realise that it was ALL a hoax?**

GW: I never found out if the original footage (tent footage) was a hoax! I was always told it was acquired from the camera man in Florida! Obviously I was involved in the filming of the second and broadcasted film. As I said earlier I was told it was a recreation of the original. You asked what I knew and I have told you! I was never party to confidential information as I was with Mastervision and Lumiere! I have never been employed or

paid by Santilli!

For me it is clear that Gareth knew very little about the complexities of the Alien Autopsy Film and he readily admits that. 

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# CONFIRMING THE ALIEN AUTOPSY HOAX, AND WHERE IT ALL BEGAN!

For those that are unaware the Alien Autopsy Film hoax began with the so-called 'TENT FOOTAGE' which had its origins with a company called AK music. Here, speaking for the very first time is Phil Jarman who was responsible for starting the whole thing off.

I recently tracked him down and he has given me permission to quote him. These are two of his e-mail's outlining how it all began.

"Hello Philip

Here is what I know and a brief history. Around 1991 I joined AK music with MD's Andy Price-Watts and Keith Bateman to start and run a Computer Animation department. We started with putting moving colour images alongside what was called Rave Music on VHS and produced Volumes called Chill Out 1, 2, and 3. We went on to produce Karaoke Videos.

Around 1994/5 Keith came to me and asked me about any UFO Stories I knew of as he knew I was into that sort of thing, so I showed him a book of the famous UFO crash at Roswell.

He told me that his contact Ray Santilli had asked him if he could produce a video of an Alien Autopsy and to make it look Authentic which we took the challenge and I must admit was fun to do.

Keith and Andy with Keith's Son and Elliot who worked in the studio went to a location to an old barn near where Andy lived to film. Keith's son played the Alien on the bench with a head that Elliot made to look like a Grey.

Elliot Played the part of the surgeon using Entrails bought from a local butcher. This was filmed in colour with very dim lighting.

Once filmed and back at the studio the film was then turned to black and white and copied many times, so to age it. My job was to produce the scratches on the film using the animation software then overlaid on the film. Now I don't know all the ins and outs of what went on but Keith was producing a video for a guy and I really can't think of his name at the moment but this video was about UFO, Aliens etc. and was about to be released when Ray Santilli hit the roof as he wanted to release it his way.

Ray came to the Studio and had a massive row with Keith so much that Ray kicked a chair and broke his toe. All I know is that Ray went of and severed his ties with Keith and to go and produce another film spending thousands of pounds this time, and I don't think he paid Keith a penny for our video.



Can you tell me why you need this information as both films now are known as Hoax and Keith has revealed on YouTube in ins and out of what happened, also the was a film on general release called "Alien Autopsy" Ant playing the part of Ray Santilli.



# UFOs & Ghosts

## What Is The Connection?

What is the connection, if any, between ghosts and UFOs? We, the human perceivers - we are the connection.

### Question One: Are ghosts a phenomenon of The Past?

By definition, ghosts "should" be in the past, being perceived by fellow humans there. Think of a street in old New Orleans, around 1800. Women scurry around in long dresses, carriages with horses rattle by, and at the docks, slaves are unloading cargo. Watching the unloading is a beautiful brown-skinned woman in simple clothing, head wrapped turban-style. She seems troubled.

Move forward to 2017, and down by the New Orleans waterfront, a young man suddenly perceives the misty, translucent form of a mixed-race woman, wearing a head-wrap, looking worried.

This would be a typical ghost-sighting: Often the ghost is from a turbulent, colourful period of time and often the ghost is unhappy. Seldom does the ghost look like solid flesh, but rather has a phantom-like appearance.

### Question Two: Are UFOs a phenomenon of The Future?

We don't know what "time" UFOs are from, let alone their

origin, but we can assume that in a hundred years, humans will have flying craft which do not fly aerodynamically like our current airplanes, but rather we will have craft which nullify gravity. Therefore our craft will be able to stop suddenly, make right angle turns, and manoeuvre in ways which airplanes cannot.



So, when a man steps out for a smoke in 2016 and suddenly spots a UFO (and how many times has this happened?!), we assume the UFO is in the 2016 skies, too, above this man. However, what if this man is perceiving *into time*, just as the young man who saw the ghost in New Orleans?

### Question Three: Does the perceiver influence what is seen?

We are told by quantum physics that the perceiver not only perceives her reality, but also influences it. One of the most bizarre premises of quantum theory states that by the very act of perceiving, the observer affects the observed reality.

Researchers at the Weizmann Institute of Science have recently conducted a highly controlled experiment demonstrating how a beam of electrons is affected by the act of being observed. The experiment revealed that the greater the amount of "watching," the greater the observer's influence on what actually takes place. Thus, this cornerstone of quantum mechanics is

again confirmed. Our minds mould reality itself.


The research team headed by Prof. Mordehai Heiblum, concluded that when a quantum "observer" is watching, particles behave as waves. When behaving as waves, they can simultaneously pass through several openings in a barrier and then meet again at the other side of the barrier. This "meeting" is known as interference.

Strange as it may sound, interference (waves) can only occur when no one is watching. Once an observer begins to watch, the picture changes dramatically: If a particle can be seen going through one opening, then it's clear it didn't go through another opening. In other words, when under observation, electrons are being "forced" to behave like particles and not like waves. Thus the mere act of observation affects the experimental findings. In fact, human observations seem to "cement" an event into solid reality, when in pure wave form, it had a number of outcomes.

So, the human perceiver of The Past is the young 2016 man who perceives the ghost on the New Orleans waterfront. The human perceiver of The Future, is the 2016 man who stepped out for a smoke and saw a UFO. What if there are eddies and streams within time itself so that once in a while, The Past filters through to an observer, and other times, a stream from The Future reaches our consciousness?

It might be that a few people have an ability to "change perception" more than the rest of us; thus we have people who have seen multiple UFOs throughout their lifetimes.

**Question Four: Is human perception affected by the Doppler Effect? The Past would signify the moving-away red shift, and The Future would signify the coming-closer blue shift.**



**Illustration: Red Shift in time ripples away, blue shift in light and time comes toward**

A quick reminder of what the Doppler Effect is: There are two Doppler Effects, one is about sound. This Doppler Effect is commonly heard when a vehicle sounding a siren passes, and recedes from an observer. The received frequency is higher

(compared to the emitted frequency) during the approach, it is identical at the instant of passing by, and it is lower during the recession.

The second Doppler Effect is in the field of physics, and it is slightly different from the sonic Doppler Effect. A celestial object moving toward us shows a blue shift (Doppler Effect) and a celestial object moving away from us shows a red shift (Doppler Effect).

**Picture: From "The Big Bang Theory," Sheldon models The Doppler Effect. We are almost always in The Present which is the dot in the middle.**



The physics Doppler phenomenon involves electromagnetism, the aberration of light, and the dilation of time.

Is it possible that ghosts and UFOs also involve electromagnetic anomalies, the "distortion" of light as it usually acts, and as time then dilates, a window opens on The Past or the Future?

**Question Five: When we spot a ghost, are we perceiving back into The Past through a peephole in time?**

Let's assume that most of the time, we are standing in the centre of the Doppler Effect. We perceive neither through the perception of the red shift nor the blue shift. We are the "normal" dot in the centre. This is what we call The Present.

Ghosts could manifest because suddenly the perception of the human observer has shifted back through time. This could happen as the observer is subject to fluctuations of light and time which happen once in a while within human consciousness, which is a part of the Cosmos. Instead of standing in the centre of the Doppler Effect, she suddenly has the "red shift" view of time. (Red shift leads to The Past, which we are moving away from).

**Question Six: When we spot a UFO, are we perceiving forward into The Future through a peephole in time? Is the observer's human consciousness suddenly functioning through a window of blue shift perception, no longer perceiving from the middle dot of The Present?**

Perhaps for *some* UFOs, it is a valid question to at least think about.

These UFOs would not be visiting us, they are going about their business in the Future, probably in the same physical spot as you now stand.

I realize that many instances of UFOs point to the fact that they are here with us in the Present. There is often more than one

observer (perceiver); also, CE2 means there is physical evidence that the UFO was here (burned marks on ground or radar confirmation). This doesn't happen often, or at least we are not told about it.

However, in a number of reports, UFOs simply wink out, as if a peephole into "some-when else" just closed. There is reason to think that in some cases, the human observer of The Present is the pivotal element of the sighting. The UFO is simply going about its business in some other time; in these cases, some fluke of The Cosmos, allowed the observer to perceive NOT in The Present.

Perhaps this is why UFO observers feel dizzy once in a while and describe the utter silence which descended during the sighting.

### **Question Seven: Why do ghosts usually belong to the near-past and not to the cave days?**

How often does someone see ghosts trudging from Africa to Europe as part of the early migration in which humans moved out of Mother Africa? How often does someone see a Neanderthal getting ready to throw a spear? Not often! It is true that observers have seen regiments of marching, ghostly Romans and apparitions of Celt warriors but these are rare.

It seems ghosts are usually of the relatively recent past. Female ghosts often have long skirts. Sometimes a servant of Victorian days can still be seen on a moonlit night, going about his duties.

Sometimes ghosts are family members. A friend of mine tells me that her grandfather still haunts the family home. Grandpa is from the recent past.

So it might be that the "red shift perception" of The Past works better if the ghost is nearer to The Present. As the red shift continues outward in the rippling pool of events/time, it grows more distant from the observer of The Present. We might perceive 1800 A.D. easier than 12,000 B.C.

Who knows if the UFOs we spot in a blue shift of perception, are from a few hundred years in The Future or 2 million years in The Future? But consider: The mystery airships of the 1800s which did not come into existence until about 1920, or consider the airplane landing strips created by The Incans. Did they see into The Future when airplanes do exist? It makes no sense that they saw UFOs because UFOs do not need landing strips – planes do. And planes would soon enough (a few hundred years), come into reality in human consciousness.

**Question Eight: Is the connection between UFOs and ghosts simply the phenomenon of time itself? UFOs shift perception to the Future while ghosts shift our perception to The Past. 99% of the time, we stand on the dot in the centre called The Present.**

Is human consciousness subject to the quantum physics of the

Cosmos? It seems impossible that human consciousness is a phenomenon outside of all the other wonders of The Universe. If we are a part of it all, then we must consider that phenomena happen to us which are directly within the workings of the vast universe all around - phenomena which have real perceptions and results.



Through my experience of setting and facilitating ufo related sky watches, meetups and meetings this has happened to myself not once but several times. I also have been facilitating events since 2007. Through the Uforia meetup group, Uforia Chronicles and it's sister group Alien's of Inner and Outer Earth headed by Charlie Kundallini , we have set up camping expeditions to places of UFO interest , which in Ontario includes lot's of forest wilderness , animals and mosquito's , sometimes excursions are not that glamorous, but bizarre and weird for sure. Bring the mosquito repellent folks.

Many other events are what is known as the UFO Sky Watches. These are usually done in a area where previous ufo sightings have occurred and or by a park or beach lake front. Sometimes we do closed door meetings at a ufo enthusiasts house or backyard. These are some of my favourites because the discussions get personal and everyone shares in the discussions and many times than not the meetings can run late in the night. Three am and we are just driving back and sometimes we stay for the most hailed witching hours of 3 am to 5 am. Having said all of that this is what hardcore ufo enthusiasts do . It's just a fact not to mention if you married the evil eye you get when you sneak into bed during the aftermath of those events. It's just part of the euphoria of ufo seeking and exploring. Not to mention if you are married one get's the are you fooling around nightmare from your spouse, that tends to happen lot's too. So warnings have been issued now, sometimes ufology outings can wear down spouses whom do not attend.

But just because you go to a sky watch or a ufo investigation or meeting does not guarantee one of having a ufo sighting. A friend of mine known in Ontario, Canada as the 'UFO MAGNET' Mr. Paul Shishis once said to me ufo watching is like fishing and sometimes you catch nothing, on film . Having said that sometimes when the cameras are down is when the stuff happens and everyone misses it. That happens too. Having said that what people should take into consideration before the ufo

Sky Watch would be the accepted resonance factor. If you get a large number of people whom are in good spirits and not afraid of seeing a ufo and not sceptical this increases the group's chances of seeing ufo's at public live events with groups of people. Also the few sceptical people attending or one's with the general attitude that they will not see a ufo during a sky watch or have a general fear of the possibility of having a sighting or better still a alien homo-sapien encounter, or have a general negative attitude should be the one's refrained from attending sky watches because they spoil it for others be decreasing the chances of having sightings due to their crappy negative outlook which broadcasts through telepathy. These people should stay at home, as they spoil the event for others.

Now comes the funny bizarre of ufo sightings and event excursions. 2011 my family and I are renting a basement apartment in Brampton, Ontario Canada. It's a small rural town with lot's of atmosphere and mosquito's depending when you are there. Known more for fishing with a population of about 500.

Tanya tells me that the sky watch event on September 1st was the first night of her two week vacation and the next day she travelled the three hour drive to Trout Creek the town she grew up in and stayed with her mom and dad. She goes on to say that that first night in Trout Creek her dad sets up a fire in the backyard and they all sit by the fire and talk and have a great time catching up. In Canada this is done as much as possible as it is really good fun plus the fact your are outside amongst the stars and in nature is awesome. That night for Tanya too there was no ufo sightings other than just good time family time. 

# Tehran UFO Incident



**SHOOT DOWN THE UFO!**



On 18 September 1976, Parviz Jafari - who later retired as a general in the Iranian Air Force - attempted to shoot down a UFO with an air-to-air missile. The UFO had been seen over Tehran and an air force commander ordered a jet to be scrambled. The jet lost instrumentation and communications when it approached the UFO and had to return to base. Jafari was piloting a second aircraft that was scrambled and as he approached the UFO in his Phantom F-4 jet he locked onto it with his radar. The object was so bright that Jafari was unable to make out its shape, though he could see multi-coloured lights flashing rapidly, like a strobe light. As he approached, he saw four smaller objects detach from the main craft. One of them came towards his aircraft. Believing he was under attack, Jafari attempted to launch a heat-seeking Sidewinder missile, but at that instant his missile control panel went dead. On his return to base, he was quizzed by an American colonel and years later, Jafari saw a Defense Intelligence Agency document on his encounter, released under the Freedom of Information Act. It stated "This case is a classic that meets all necessary conditions for a legitimate study of the UFO phenomenon". That was interesting, given that the US government's public position is that official UFO investigations ceased in 1969 when the United States Air Force closed down their research programme, Project Blue Book.

Parviz Jafari is not the only military pilot to have made an attempt to shoot down a UFO. On 11 April 1980, Oscar Alfonso Santa Maria Huertas, a pilot with the Peruvian Air Force, was scrambled to intercept a spherical UFO hovering in restricted military airspace. His unit commander's orders were clear: shoot down the UFO. As Santa Maria Huertas closed on the object in his Sukhoi-22 fighter, he strafed it with his 30mm canon, firing 64 shells at the UFO. He saw some of his projectiles hit the craft, but they had no effect. "The projectiles didn't bounce off", he said. "Probably, they were absorbed". He vectored his air-

craft for another attack, but on this occasion the UFO took evasive action and a bizarre and potentially deadly game of cat and mouse ensued. At one point, Santa Maria Huertas got within 300 feet of the UFO, which he described in the following terms: "It was about 30 feet in diameter. It was an enamelled, cream-colored dome, with a wide, circular, metallic base. It had no engines, no exhausts, no windows, no wings or antennae. It lacked all the typical aircraft components, with no visible propulsion system".



On 12 November 2007 Jafari and Santa Maria Huertas told their stories together in public for the first time, at a historic event held at the National Press Club in Washington DC. A group of people with backgrounds in government, the military and the aviation community came together to lobby the US government to re-open Project Blue Book. There were 14 panellists from 7 countries. All the panellists had either seen a UFO while on active service or undertaken official research and investigation into UFO sightings. None took any position on the exact nature of the UFO phenomenon, but all agreed that it raises important defence, national security and aviation safety issues. The event was organised by filmmaker James Fox and investigative journalist Leslie Kean, from the Coalition for Freedom of Information - an organisation advised by John Podesta, who was Chief of Staff to President Clinton.


Two of the participant's had been witnesses to Britain's best-known UFO sighting, which took place in Rendlesham Forest in Suffolk. Jim Penniston was in charge of security at RAF Woodbridge (a United States Air Force base) when on 26 December 1980, reports came in of lights in the forest that lay beyond the perimeter fence. Thinking an aircraft had crashed, he and colleagues went out to investigate. What they actually

found was a UFO that had landed in a small clearing. "When we came up on the triangular-shaped craft there were blue and yellow lights swirling around the exterior ... the air around us was electrically charged. We could feel it on our clothes, skin and hair. Nothing in my training prepared me for what we were witnessing", Penniston explained. He described how he and the others took photographs (that they were told later had been over-exposed) and made sketches of the craft, including strange pictorial symbols seen on the hull, before the UFO took off and accelerated away to the horizon. "Speed: impossible", Penniston wrote in his logbook. The other witness was the Deputy Base Commander, Lieutenant Colonel Charles Halt, who witnessed the UFO two nights later and saw it fire light beams into the weapons storage area at RAF Woodbridge. "I have no idea what we saw but do know whatever we saw was under intelligent control", Halt stated.

I was one of the participants at the National Press Club event, as between 1991 and 1994 my duties at the Ministry of Defence had included investigating UFO sightings, to assess whether they were of any "defence significance", a phrase which - perhaps deliberately - is virtually impossible to define. The British government has looked into the UFO phenomenon since 1950 and to date has received over 10,000 UFO reports. Most sightings can be easily explained as misidentifications of ordinary objects and phenomena, but around 5% remain unexplained. The MoD receives more Freedom of Information Act requests relating to UFOs than on any other subject, including the conflicts in Iraq and Afghanistan. The Department is in the process of releasing many of its old UFO files (including ones from the Defence Intelligence Staff) though the size of the job means that full disclosure is likely to take several years.

The other British participant at the Washington DC gathering was Captain Ray Bowyer, a commercial airline pilot who saw two UFOs in the vicinity of the Channel Islands on 23 April 2007. He described the objects as being "a flattened disk shape with a dark area to the right side". He said they were "brilliant yellow with light emanating from them". He estimated them as being up to a mile across. Some of his passengers saw the UFOs as did at least one other pilot in the area. An anomalous return was detected on radar. The MoD's investigation was inconclusive, but the French government - in whose airspace the UFOs were adjudged to be - is continuing to look into the incident.


The National Press Club event was moderated by Fife Symington, a former Governor of Arizona who was previously in the United States Air Force. In 1997 a vast delta-shaped UFO was seen by hundreds of people in Phoenix and Symington, as Governor, held a press conference to address the situation. Concerned at what he felt was a rising state of panic, he forced his reluctant Chief of Staff to dress up in an alien suit. The stunt made headlines and certainly lightened the mood, but the real story emerged only last year, when Symington admitted that he too had seen the UFO in the skies over Phoenix. As it happened, he wasn't the first politician to have seen a UFO. Former Presidents Jimmy Carter and



Ronald Reagan both had sightings and 2008 presidential candidate Dennis Kucinich recently confirmed that he has seen a UFO.

Another speaker at the 12 November event was Wilfried De Brouwer, a retired Major General who served formerly as Chief of Staff of the Belgian Air Force. De Brouwer spoke about a wave of UFO sightings that occurred in Belgium in 1989 and 1990. "Hundreds of people saw a majestic triangular craft with a span of approximately 120 feet, powerful beaming spot lights, moving very slowly without making any significant noise but, in several cases, accelerating to very high speeds", he explained. He went on to say that on three occasions F-16 aircraft had been launched in unsuccessful attempts to intercept UFOs and said that on one occasion the F-16 radars showed the UFO performing "rapid changes in speed and altitude which were well outside of the performance envelope of existing aircraft". Some researchers suggest that sightings such as this are attributable to stealth aircraft or other experimental aircraft, but De Brouwer explained that this possibility was discounted, following consultation with NATO allies.

One of the reasons the various panellists travelled to Washington DC was a growing frustration with the position of the US government. Nothing illustrates the reason for this frustration better than the official reaction to an event that occurred on 7 November 2006 when numerous airline personnel at O'Hare International Airport in Chicago witnessed a disc-shaped UFO hovering over one of the terminal buildings at a height of around 2000 feet. After several minutes it accelerated away upwards so rapidly that it punched a hole in the cloud cover. Since the object was not tracked on radar, the Federal Aviation Administration declined to investigate, dismissing the sighting as probably attributable to a "weather phenomenon". Picking up on this point, the declaration signed by the panellists states: "We suggest that prejudice against the term 'UFO' and against



reports of unknowns could lead officials to dismiss sightings that involve unconventional aircraft or unmanned aerial vehicles engaged in espionage or terrorist activity, especially when radar returns are not available". If such words came from UFO enthusiasts, they might be ignored. Coming from generals, government officials and pilots, they are more difficult to dismiss.

With flight safety issues in mind, it was interesting that one of the signatories to the declaration was John Callahan, a former Divisional Chief of the FAA's Accidents and Investigations Branch in Washington DC. Callahan described how he had investigated a 1986 incident where the pilot and crew of a Japan Air Lines Boeing 747 encountered a UFO over Alaska. They described a spherical object four times the size of their

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adjusting their night vision devices for landing. The landing was further complicated by excessive interference on UHF and a further complete loss of all communications when passing through a 150 degree magnetic bearing from the home base. The inertial navigation system simultaneously fluctuated from 30 to 50 degrees. A civil airliner approaching the area also experienced a similar communications failure, but reported no unusual sightings.

While on a long final approach, the F-4 crew noted a further UFO. This was described as a cylinder-shaped object (about the size of a T-33 trainer) with bright steady lights on each end and a flasher in the middle. It quickly approached and passed directly over the F-4. In answer to the pilot's query, the control tower reported no other air traffic in the area, although they subsequently obtained a visual sighting of the object when specifically directed where to look.

The following day, the F-4 crew was flown by helicopter to the location where they believed the object had landed. This turned out to be a dry lake bed, but nothing unusual was noticed. As the helicopter circled off to the west, however, a very noticeable beeper signal was received, and eventually traced to a nearby house. They immediately landed and asked the inhabitants if anything strange or unusual had occurred the previous night. Yes, they replied, there had been loud noises and a very bright light, like lightning. The helicopter returned to base and arrangements were made to conduct various tests, such as radiation checks, in the vicinity of the house. Unfortunately, the results of such tests have not been reported.

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January 1995, involving a Boeing 737 on approach to Manchester airport. When over the Pennines at a height of 4000 feet, both the pilot and the first officer saw an unidentified object pass down the right hand side of the aircraft at high speed. It was described as wedge-shaped, illuminated, with what looked like a black stripe down the side. Neither man was certain how close the object had come to colliding with the aircraft (which was carrying 60 passengers) but the first officer instinctively ducked as it went by. On this occasion, nothing unusual was seen on radar. The CAA's report into this incident (entitled Airmis Report No. 2/95) concluded "Having debated the various hypotheses at length the Group concluded that, in the absence of any firm evidence which could identify or explain the object, it was not possible to assess either the cause or the risk by any of the normal criteria applicable to Airmis reports. The incident therefore remains unresolved".

There is a huge misconception about the UFO phenomenon. Many people dismiss sightings as the work of over-active imaginations and treat the whole subject as if it were a joke. To be fair, most UFOs do turn out to be misidentifications. Furthermore, there are some outrageous hoaxes perpetrated and tall tales told. And yet, as the recent event at the National Press Club illustrated, there is a serious and potentially sinister side to all of this. Some UFOs are

own aircraft. Callahan's investigation included a review of the voice tapes and the radar data. As with so many of these cases involving pilots, the radar tapes confirmed that there had indeed been a large object following the Japanese aircraft. In one of the few conspiratorial moments of the National Press Club event, Callahan revealed how a briefing was set up for some of President Reagan's scientific staff, where one of three CIA attendees concluded by stating "This event never happened; we were never here; we're confiscating all this data and you are all sworn to secrecy".

seen by reliable witnesses such as pilots. They are tracked on radar, performing speeds and manoeuvres that exceed the capabilities of our most sophisticated aircraft. Attempts have been made to shoot down at least two UFOs - maybe there are other such cases that have never been disclosed. Finally, there are the people lobbying for action. Not UFO enthusiasts, but generals, pilots and government officials. All their backgrounds check out and all their accounts can be backed up by an audit trail of documents from official archives. When people like this call for the UFO phenomenon to be taken more seriously, maybe it's time to listen.

How seriously should the flight safety angle be taken? In the UK, the Civil Aviation Authority has several cases on its files involving near misses between commercial aircraft and UFOs. None is more disturbing than an incident that occurred on 6

# A Message from the ETs

In my research into people who have been taken inside UFOs, I have noticed many patterns. While physical examinations are perhaps the most common feature of onboard encounters, equally prominent are cases in which people have been given messages from the ETs. In most instances, the messages fall into three main categories: warnings of upcoming environmental disasters, information about alternative energy sources and finally, teachings about healing and spirituality. It appears that the ETs are very interested in helping us and our planet.

In 1982, U.S. Navy corpsman, Kevin Kammann was taken from a Navy ship into a UFO piloted by fifteen-foot-tall Praying Mantis ETs. They had milky-white skin, huge heads, and eyes the size of basketballs. The aliens had no desire to physically examine Kevin. Instead they imparted a warning about upcoming disasters on our planet.

After explaining where they came from and many other things about themselves, they told Kevin that when humans discovered and began testing atomic weaponry, it caused them to pay much closer attention, and that it also drew the interest of other ETs.

Says Kevin, "They told me that when we exploded the atom bomb, that started a countdown clock."

At that point, they didn't explain what they meant by a "countdown clock," but Kevin had the impression that it meant some type of apocalyptic scenario.

They then showed him a series of future natural disasters that would occur on various locations of the planet, all on a vivid three-dimensional screen, as if he were actually there, surveying the scene from a window. Says Kevin, "They showed me mudslides and volcanic eruptions, hurricanes and floods, and more hurricanes. These were natural disasters that were going to happen."

"These are things that are going to come," they said. "Your destiny will be fulfilled."

As the years passed, Kevin was shocked to watch some of the disasters he had seen aboard the UFO actually take place. His encounter had a profound effect on his life, and since then, he has gone public with his experience and is trying to spread the message given to him by the ETs.

An equally compelling case is that of Jim Kuebelbeck, a Navy aviation electronics tech-



nician. One evening in 1960, while on duty aboard the USS Valley Forge in the Mediterranean Sea, he and several of his fellow officers had a profound sighting of unexplained lights. Strangely, the next day, most of the officers were unable to remember seeing the UFO. The event had been completely wiped from their minds.

Kuebelbeck was baffled. Not only did he remember the sighting, he also remembered much more. The evening of the encounter, he had a "dream" which he now believes was actually an attempt by the ETs to make contact.

In the "dream," he found himself with a group of human-looking men who seemed to be intent on teaching him about





alternative energy. They were discussing that the combustion engine had been invented out of a need to improve on the horse-driven cart.


The men then told him that there were many other sources of energy available besides the combustion engine. "You have momentum," they told him. "There is the sun, Magnetism, Centrifugal force. There are an endless number of forces. Do not limit yourself by what you have been told. Such limitations are negative in nature... The only limitations mankind is what he has created in his mind. His negative limitations and restrictions have been created by his own thought processes. Gifts from God are boundless and limitless, never-ending. They can be used as power sources to generate whatever energy sources man desires or needs in any stage of evolution. The very problems you are talking about can be eliminated, and the very concepts you desire, you can achieve. Any problem you visualize can also be un-visualized. If man changes his concept of limitations, there will be no limitations. It's that simple."

While there was much more to the entire encounter, Keubelbeck was most impressed by the discussion of alternative energy. Many years later, his experience inspired to build his own perpetual-motion device. While it didn't work forever, it did spin for a very long time. More recently he became interested in dowsing and became an extremely successful water-dowser in his area.

Many other cases like this exist. In my book, *Not from Here*, I discuss ten first hand cases in which people were taken onboard, and sometimes given messages by the ETs--messages that have the potential to benefit all of humanity. The question is: will we listen?

On January 23, 2017, we decided to visit an old RAF airbase in Cambridgeshire. I must say what a place it is. RAF Upwood was built as 2 separate sections one in 1917 and the other section in 1936.

It was used by the United States Air Force. Upwood, along with RAF Molesworth and RAF Alconbury, are considered the "Tri-Base Area" due to their close geographic proximity, and interdependency.

We only had a rough idea where this place was and by the time we got there it was very dark.

We were searching for the base for 2 hours, but had no luck. We were about to give up when we noticed a small building in the distance. We decided to walk towards it. There it was in front of us. Huge monster structures. It was breath-taking.

We decided to just go straight into the investigation. I immediately grabbed my voice recorder and thermal imaging camera and walked through the door. It was like time had just stopped. I had an extremely eerie feeling.

At that point, I decided to ask some questions. "Hello, is there anyone here that would like to speak with us?" Suddenly we heard a big bang. It made us jump out of our skin. We looked at each other and asked, "What was that?"

As I walked in, the word "trap" came up on the ovilus. I looked around and noticed the beams were burnt and the room was dangerous, so I stepped out. I then heard the word come from the ovilus. I knew at this point the spirit of Joan was not alone. I asked who this

bad entity was. We heard the biggest scream come from upstairs. We ran up the stairs and found 2 rooms. One on the right and one on the left. We stepped into the room to the right and could hear the most horrible sound. It was like a huge animal dying for breath. We felt extremely uncomfortable in this room so we left. As soon as we did, the sound stopped.

On our way to the room on the left, I noticed there was a line of salt at the door. I thought that was very strange. The minute we walked in to the room, we see nothing but sacrifice signs and pentagrams as well. We also see spots of blood and more salt circles and lines.

We did some extensive EVP work in there and had more communication with Joan. We found out she died at the age of 34 and had 2 children. Then all of a sudden communication with Joan just stopped.



# IT DIDN'T CRASH IT LANDED!

This is the first in a series of articles on this world famous UFO event which Ronnie Dugdale has compiled from the spoken facts, made by the immediate witnesses involved, and those surrounding the events such as the local Police force and others. Many are aware of the event of course, but how many know the sequence of events?

We at OLM are grateful to Ronnie for taking the time to compile this information for our readers.



## By Ronnie Dugdale Part 1

December 1980 the airspace of the U.S. military base is invaded by UFOs over several nights among the dozens of witnesses are high-ranking USAF Officers.

Almost immediately critical evidence disappears and a cover-up begins amid claims of brainwashing and intimidation but the cover-up can't stop civilians from coming forward to corroborate the sightings. A top-secret memo confirming the events unleashes a firestorm. Amazingly part of the encounter is captured on audio tape by the deputy base Commander Charles Halt who had gone out to the forest a sceptic and came back wishing he had never gone.

The story begins in rural Suffolk an area known for its dark and mysterious history. Rendlesham Forest in Suffolk East Anglia is about 70 miles or so north east of London it is an area with a darker and more subdued military test history.

The whole east coast of England area, for decades was used for military weapons research, radar research, all sorts of strange tales from the Second World War about villages being evacuat-

ed because of secret experiments involving death rays and burned bodies found on the beaches. Fishermen being paid to keep out of the waters, Prisons being put on evacuation alert and strange plasma orbs and beams of light were regularly seen by mariners off the Suffolk coast.

Not far from this area, separated by a slice of Rendlesham Forest were two key military installations so close together they were called the twin bases.

RAF Bentwaters and RAF Woodbridge served as British installations until 1951 when they were leased to the United States. In 1980 the twin bases ranked among the most important US military outpost in the world. More than one thousand aircraft and some 4,000 air force personnel stood ready to defend or attack as necessary.

The Bentwaters/Woodbridge air bases housed tactical nuclear weapons that could be used to thwart potential Soviet aggression.

### 25th -26th Dec 1980 RAF Bentwaters and Woodbridge The First Night


Between midnight and sunrise of December 26, 1980, Airman 1st Class John Burroughs, Staff Sergeant James Penniston and

Airman Ed Cabansag went into the Rendlesham Forest to investigate colourful orange, red, white and blue lights that were moving through the tall pine trees in a section of Rendlesham forest known as Tangham woods.

It was some time after midnight, Christmas day had just ended and it is now the early hours of the morning on Boxing Day, the 26th of December 1980. Because it was Christmas there was only skeleton staffs on duty at RAF Bentwaters and Woodbridge.

One of the checks they were tasked to do was to ensure that the east gate commonly known as the back gate of the Woodbridge base was securely locked. This gate, often used as a shortcut was not usually manned after 6 p.m. Several people knew the combination of the lock and it was sometimes found to be left unsecured.

As they drove up to the east gate Budd Steffens noticed some strange lights in the forest, the lights appeared to be hovering at about tree-top level. The red, white and blue lights looked at



C flight had just started their 3rd midnight shift. Staff Sgt Budd Steffens, fairly new to the base, was the Law enforcement supervisor that night. 19 year old Airman 1st class John Burroughs had been on the base for 17 months.

Christmas songs were being played over the radio net, the guys were goofing around, it was Christmas, the air base was quiet and no aircraft were flying.

Budd Steffans contacted John and asked if he wanted to join him on patrol so they could get better acquainted.

first like a Christmas light display and they seemed to be originating from the edge of Rendlesham Forest.

Being new to the job Budd Steffens asked John if he had ever seen lights like that in the forest, John said he had never seen anything like it there before. As they were not sure what they were dealing with they decided that they would go off base, drive down the east gate road in their patrol vehicle and take a closer look.

As they got nearer it became apparent to them that the lights were quite close, much closer than they had originally thought. They arrived at the junction where the east gate road meets the

main forest service road and turned their truck around to face back towards the east gate.

At that moment a large white spherical light moved towards them, as if mirroring their movement. It now seemed closer than ever, this startled them and they didn't like what they were feeling; Burroughs and Steffens decided to return to the East Gate to call it in to the law enforcement desk.

When they arrived back at the east gate John Burroughs rang through on the landline in the guard shack to Sgt "Crash" McCabe who was manning the law enforcement desk. This was normal procedure when relaying sensitive information as it was commonplace for enthusiasts to listen in to the radio chatter from the base using scanners.

John Burroughs had a history of playing practical jokes on Sgt McCabe and because of that he was having trouble getting McCabe to take him seriously.

McCabe thought this was just Burroughs winding him up again with his idea of a Christmas practical joke so McCabe asked to speak to Bud Steffens.

John passed the phone over to Steffens who confirmed everything that Burroughs had said was true, adding that if he didn't believe him to send someone down to the gate as the lights were still visible.

McCabe still unsure if Burroughs was joking about said he would put a call through to Sgt John Coffey at Central Security Control thinking that if Burroughs was bluffing it would prompt him to own up to the joke. When John Burroughs done nothing McCabe realised John was being serious and put a call through to Central Security Control.

Assuming it must be a downed aircraft Sgt Coffey called Staff Sergeant James W. Penniston who was the on duty flight chief at RAF Woodbridge that night. Penniston says he was having a snack when he received the call. Sgt Coffey told Penniston to rendezvous with John Burroughs and Budd Steffens down at the East gate. Penniston wanted to know what the nature of the incident was down there but Sgt Coffey said he would rather not tell him and refused to give him any further details telling him he would get briefed by the patrolmen Burroughs and Steffens on arrival at the east gate.

***"I received a call from Central Security Control saying to phone in to their office which I did immediately .I asked Sergeant Coffey what the problem was and Coffey told me I needed to get down to the east gate and contact John Burroughs as a matter of some urgency. I again asked them what was the nature of the problem was down there and he said that he would rather not tell me, but to get down there as quick as possible and talk to the patrol men on the scene.", recalled Penniston.***

Jim Penniston was driven to the East Gate by Edward Cabansag who was a new recruit to the base. Cabansag being new to the job had a growing suspicion that perhaps he was

being set up with a prank. On arriving at east gate, John Burroughs and Bud Steffens explained to Jim Penniston what they had seen and pointed out down the east gate road into the forest to where the lights were.

### **It didn't crash, it landed.**

When Sgt Penniston showed up Bud Steffens went over to him and they started talking. Penniston walked over to the gate with his rider Ed Cabansag and looked out into the Forest. He could see the strange lights out there in the forest too. Penniston asks Steffens if he saw it crash Steffens replied, ***"It didn't crash, it landed."***

Sgt James Penniston placed a call to the central security control from the east gate guard shack. They told him they had no scheduled flying at all that evening. They started to do some checking, they called rapcon which would have been their radar on Bentwaters to find out if they had anything on radar. They called Eastern Radar and they also called Heathrow tower.

Eastern Radar based at RAF Watton and London Heathrow both advised they had tracked a bogey but they had lost contact with it when it dropped off their radar screens somewhere in the vicinity of the Rendlesham forest. With this in mind Master Sgt Chandler contacted the shift commander's office, and within a minute or so Sgt Penniston had got the go-ahead to proceed off base to conduct an investigation.

Budd Steffens refused to go off base; he was scared, something just didn't seem right to him, he had heard about mysterious lights in the forest previously from his fellow airmen so Penniston took his driver Ed Cabansag and airman first class John Burroughs.

The USAF had a Status Forces Agreement with the British Government that forbid the US Airmen to take their weapons off base so they left their weapons behind at the gate with MSgt Chandler who had joined them down at the East Gate. It is possible John Burroughs held on to his 38 sidearm.

All of a sudden the Christmas music being broadcast over the radio net went silent. Donnie Dillard who had been broadcasting requests over the radio calls for all unnecessary radio communication to cease. He tells everyone there was a serious situation being investigated over at the Woodbridge base. Airmen on duty at both Woodbridge and Bentwaters were now all ears, wondering what on earth was going on.

Sgt Penniston, John Burroughs and Ed Cabansag, drove down the East gate road, took a right turn into the main forest service road .

As John Burroughs looked over to his left he could see in the distance green, red, orange and white lights out in the forest. It looked to him like a Christmas display. They turned left down a logging service track heading eastward towards the lights. The rough frozen track was difficult to negotiate. Eventually they came upon a fence that blocked their path and so all three disembarked and proceeded on foot.

Penniston Burroughs and Cabansag headed towards where they

could see the lights out in the dense forest. It appeared as a white light with a bit of orange tinge in it..

***“As we were heading out I thought this is a prank I thought okay three four days on with my flight there's a big huge mud puddle out here and they're gonna throw me in the mud. As we got closer and closer I could see the intensity on both the other gentleman's faces. I knew that this was really going to be something more involved than a prank.” [Ed Cabansag]***

From the moment they entered the forest their radios started acting up. There was a repeater at Woodbridge base to kick the signal to Bentwaters and under normal circumstances that would have been sufficient to boost the signal but it appears the radio interference was being caused by what ever it was in the forest. The closer they got to the lights the more interference their radio suffered .

The animals in the forest at this time were running around in frenzy and making a lot of noise. Airmen listening on the radios were hearing all this commotion and wondering what was happening and why had the airmen gone off base into the Queens forest.

The shift commander and Sgt Penniston were still thinking they were attending to a downed aircraft

Meanwhile, back at the Bentwaters base having heard the chatter over the radio airman Bertolino and a colleague climbed to the top of Bunker Hill an elevated position close to the flight line. From this vantage point they hoped to see the lights and find out what all the fuss was all about.

Bertolino remembers seeing a luminescent glow about the size of a football pitch which had a dome like quality to it. It appeared to light a certain area but beyond that the light never radiated out. It was a strange light like nothing he had ever seen before.

The next thing Bertolino remembers was overhearing Sgt Penniston on the radio saying it was dark out there, the bright light had gone out but the blue and orange beacon lights were still visible.

***“As they were going into the woods I'll never forget the one transmission that first made my hair stand up – and it still does to this day. You could hear a little heavy breathing walking through the woods, and he [Penniston] says ‘security control the object is about 150 feet in front of us’. And then - I mean it was just a matter of a couple of seconds - he comes back and is breathing a little heavier and he goes ‘security, do you copy that the object is behind us now? Penniston seemed agitated. Since Bertolino and his colleague could not see anything from Bunker Hill and the CSC had now called for radio silence there was no point in continuing their vigil. Bertolino and his colleague got on with their regular patrols and security checks. Unusually they did not receive any further radio transmissions, “[Bertolino, Earthfiles interview].”***

On a couple of occasions they seemed to be getting closer to

what ever it was that was lighting up the forest but then it seemed to move away, it appeared at one point to be toying with them. John Burroughs remembers on occasions getting close to the lights but then it appeared to be further away again. John Burroughs cannot remember the transmission overheard by Bertolino .That same transmission was also overheard by Paul Tucsynski, who was listening to the chatter from his post close to the WSA at Bentwaters. Perhaps as John Burroughs has suggested to me James Penniston was just that bit further ahead of him and out of ear shot at that time.

The men were moving through the woods at a pretty good pace. They were spread out in a line formation. Penniston led the way followed 15-20 metres behind by Burroughs and then Cabansag at the rear.

The closer Burroughs and Penniston got to the lights the less it seemed like a crashed aircraft., had it been an aircraft crash you would of expected small fires to be burning all over the forest floor and debris strewn amongst the trees but there was no evidence of this at all. Things just didn't add up, something wasn't right. There was no odour of leaking fuel typical of a crashed aircraft and the cluster of lights appeared too concentrated to be a crash. Communications were becoming difficult and the interference was now getting much worse.

***“We were in constant contact to a point so even though I wasn't receiving it didn't really mean a lot to me but I still went on transmitting .I have to report what's going on we are outside our installation and with the resources going on around that base I better be reporting every five minutes or they're going to send somebody else out there and I did not want anybody out there until I could ascertain what was in front of us” [Jim Penniston]***

It was clear very early on that something wasn't quite right. Penniston had attended dozens of crashes before so knew exactly what he had to do but this didn't seem like anything he had experienced before. The air was filled with static electricity, the hair on their arms and backs of their necks was standing on end the static charge was so strong they could feel their hair pushing their berets from their heads.

***“There was some distortion on the perception of time, the time out there seemed to go awful fast 30 or 45 minutes felt like two or three minutes, at this point in time I realized it wasn't an aircraft crash, I wasn't getting the smell of fuel burning .My job was, identify, get facts ,report the facts let someone else make the assessment.” [Jim Penniston]***

Everything seemed to be at a slower pace and even walking was difficult it seemed almost like wading waist high through water.

Soon they came upon a clearing where the lights were emanating from. The lights were so intense that a large area of the forest was illuminated. Sgt Penniston has often stated that he left Ed Cabansag at the tree line to act as a radio relay but clearly from what Cabansag has said he must have been with them in the forest at least at some stage.

***“Burroughs would say, “do you see that? Do you see what’s out there at the edge of the trees”?. And I’m looking and looking and I’m going “what are you seeing?, what are you seeing “? And he extended his finger out puts my head to his end of his finger and says, “Look at the end of my finger” “It was maybe a hundred yards, hundred and fifty yards. I couldn’t quite tell if it was silvery it was moving left right left right. Nothing could move the way it moved at the time. Nothing could move that quick. Everything that I had seen in my technical school that I was privileged under secret clearance to see didn’t look anything like that”. [Ed Cabansag]***

After a while they came across a berm they made their way to the top and as they came down the other side. It was sat there right in front of them.

Now they were close to the lights the atmosphere seemed to change .There was no sound, no rustling of the trees, no wind, and no animal sounds even the sky seemed different. All of the sudden the light intensified, it got really bright. The forest lit up just like it was daytime, there was a silent explosion of light. The men dived to the ground. Penniston yelled to John Burroughs' to open fire on it. Now this is where the incident gets interesting. All three of the airmen have very different recollections of what they witnessed.

### **How John Burroughs remembers their encounter**

After seeing the white light silently explode John Burroughs hit the ground he remembers seeing a red, oval sun like object in the clearing. It lifted up through the trees and shot back towards the coast. . It seemed to John that from the time he hit the ground to the UFO departing was only a matter of seconds. With the craft now gone Burroughs and Penniston ventured out towards the coast to see if they could relocate the UFO. They moved out of the forest across the fence into the farmer’s field towards the coast.

At one time they got so close to it they thought it was going to land again but it took off towards the east and out to sea.

***“The woods lit up and you could hear the farm animals making a lot of noise and there was a lot of movement in the woods. All three of us hit the ground and whatever it was started moving back towards the open field and after a min or two we got up and moved into the trees and the lights moved out into the open field. We got up to a fence that separated the trees from the open field and you could see the lights down by a farmer’s house. We climbed over the fence and started heading towards the red and blue lights and they just disappeared.” [Burroughs, official witness statement].***

Once they got out into the field they followed it for a good mile maybe a mile and a half to a vantage point high up on a hill where they had a clear view out to the coast .In the distance

they could see the beacon from the Orford Ness lighthouse. By now communications had been lost by the Central Security Control for some 45 minutes and they were getting very concerned, just as they were about to send out a search party communication was resumed and at 03.45 hrs they were told to end their investigation and head back to base. Dazed and confused they started to make their way back.

It was while they were making their way back they briefly saw a blue light as it streaked past them.

***“We had just crossed a creak and were told to come back when we saw a blue light to our left in the trees. It was only there for a min and it streaked away.” [Burroughs, official witness statement]***

Walking back to the base they are discussing how the hell they are going to explain what they had witnessed. There is no way they could explain how it did what it did. They didn’t want to have to explain a UFO thing, it could ruin their careers.

When they got back to the base they realised they had lost contact with them for 45 minutes.

### **How Sgt James Penniston remembers their encounter**

Having suffered no ill effects from the blast Sgt Penniston raised to his feet, it was clear this was no aircraft crash. A bright sphere of light was in front of them. Penniston glanced over to his right and was shocked to see Burroughs engulfed in a beam of white light shining down from above he was standing motionless, Sgt Penniston shouted to Burroughs but he gave no reaction.

The bright sphere of light had now dissipated and to Jim's amazement in its place sat a triangular craft of unknown origin. Penniston approached the craft to commence his assessment, the craft measured about 7-8ft high and approximately 9 ft. across the base .There was absolutely no sound coming from the craft whatsoever. Sgt Penniston could find no sign of engines, any crew compartments, nor any windows or doors. He looked around the craft expecting to see NASA or USAF or even USSR written on the side but instead of seeing a recognisable mark he found some strange symbols that appeared to be etched into the craft itself. They seemed familiar to Jim but he couldn’t work out why or where he had seen them before.

***“It was probably the most different thing I’ve ever investigated my entire life, anything i could see i would go ahead and write down. Structure of craft, fabric black smooth glass-like, surface unknown, the identity unknown. I paced off the size of the craft and taking notes on the distance size nine feet long approximately seven eight feet high. I could tell what was the front or the back i had trouble when I was walking around the craft to distinguish engines .propulsions unknown ,no sound but apparently operating somehow .type of aircraft unknown” [Jim Penniston]***

The fabric of the craft was seamless it had the appearance of

black glass, almost like it was carved from black onyx. Penniston began taking photographs and had soon used up a full roll of film he got out his police issue note book and began sketching and writing down notes of what was in front of him. He observed the craft from every angle. Penniston ran his hand over the craft, it felt smooth and warm to the touch as he ran his hand over the symbols they felt as though they were etched and the texture was like that of sandpaper.

***“Certain things didn’t make sense; I couldn’t determine the front that was the problem. Second it seems running but there was no sound, third was the aspect of having electricity in the air, I could feel it in my clothing, my hair my skin. The next one is after I got up close to the craft the writing changes, it changes from being written competently to shaky”. [Jim Penniston]***

As Penniston touched the symbols the light emanating from the craft intensified and he became struck with fear but as soon as he removed his hand the light dissipated and all feeling of fear was gone.

After a while the craft silently rose up off the ground and manoeuvred up and through the trees. As soon as the UFO was clear of the tree tops it shot off at an impossible speed and was gone in the blink of an eye.

On the eve of the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Rendlesham Forest Incident Sgt Penniston revealed that he had been keeping a secret for thirty years. He claims that when he touched the symbols etched on to the side of the craft he received a telepathic binary code download. Thousands of 1’s and 0’s flashed in front of his minds eye.

The following day at his Ipswich home Sgt Penniston says he could not get the 1’s and 0’s out of his head and felt compelled to write them down, page after page. When he had finished writing them down he said he then felt at ease.

## **How Ed Cabansag remembers their encounter**

The problem we have with figuring out the participation Ed Cabansag had with the incident is that he has kept himself very private and has only given the odd interview and nothing for many years now. His official statement can be for the best part ignored, he claims he never made that statement and it contains many errors. His statement was written for him and typed. Ed could not type. It is for that reason I have selected information from an interview Ed conducted with Georgina Bruni for her book *You Can’t tell The People*. Col halt had informed Georgina that Ed held a responsible position with the government and for that reason would not talk to her or anybody. Not true, Ed never held a government position and when Georgina tracked him down she found he was willing to talk.

Ed told Georgina he remembers being in Lt. Colonel Halts office on the morning of the 26th terrified that he would be facing a Lt. Colonel who was also the deputy base commander. He

does not remember making a statement and said the only thing he ever signed was for Colonel Halt. He doesn’t remember what it was that he signed. He can’t even remember talking to Halt because he was so nervous and scared. He told Georgina he was so nervous he would have signed anything he was told to even without reading it.

Before he went to see Col Halt Eds fellow airmen advised him to just do as they say, that way, he was told, you will keep out of trouble and that says Ed, is what he done.

Ed Cabansags recollection of the beginning of the incident mirrors that remembered by Penniston and Burroughs. They agree up to the point where they have entered the Rendlesham forest expecting to find a downed aircraft and pursue the lights for a while, but from the time they climbed the berm and were confronted with whatever it was on the other side Ed Cabansag says John Burroughs drew his 38 and then they all passed out. Ed Cabansag recalls seeing unusual coloured lights as they entered the forest and remembers the radios acting up. SSgt Penniston claims he posted Ed back at their vehicle to act as a communication relay but Ed does not remember ever being separated from the patrol.

***“Because I was new, and probably green, I thought it was some sort of prank or fraternity thing like they do in college. I recall being assigned to security One. Driving Penniston over to the east gate and meeting up with Burroughs and Steffens. We thought it was going to be a downed aircraft. It was Burroughs who made the report. We had to wait for Master Sergeant Chandler to meet us because we had to hand our weapons over to him and get permission to proceed further. I’ve read all that stuff about me being a com-link, but I can’t remember any of that. I remember being with Penniston and Burroughs, there were only three of us, Sergeant Chandler stayed back with the jeep. We all saw something. And I kept thinking this is a joke. But as we got closer and closer we could see a light, and our radio transmissions were cutting out. I remember what I saw it was to the right of the lighthouse. It was cone shaped-egg shaped, with lights running around its belt from left to right. They were blue red and white lights. Flashing, sometimes rapid, sometimes slow. Then we saw flakes of metal coming from it. It is difficult to describe. We were all trying to make sure what we had seen. . . . it wasn’t the lighthouse, I saw the lighthouse, this wasn’t it. It was to the right of the lighthouse” [The evidence of Ed Cabansag Georgina Bruni, You Can’t Tell The People]***

Interestingly Ed Cabansag does not have any recollection of ever seeing a landed object in the forest or pursuing it for two miles. He was very concerned after reading SSgt. Penniston’s account of what happened to realise he has a memory loss from that period right up until they saw the object to the right of the lighthouse. Ed wonders if perhaps he was told not to discuss it or maybe “They “blocked it from his memory. That tells me he must have been debriefed.

***“I’m very confused. I may have been with Chandler but then I can’t remember separating from Burroughs and Penniston. Why do I just recall?-I have a blank. I really don’t remember anything about the thing landing”*** [The evidence of Ed Cabansag Georgina Bruni, *You Can’t Tell The People*]

It would appear that Ed Cabansag could recall the before and after parts of the incident but not what happened in between. He had either experienced missing time or his memory had been altered or erased. There is a big chunk of time missing from his memory. Cabansag cannot remember getting back in the vehicle and returning to the base either. That’s very interesting in light of new evidence put forward recently by airman “Cookie” in a recent Phenomenon radio show hosted by John Burroughs. Cookie claims to have driven the men back to Bentwaters where they were met by the man in the white coat and his team. The person Col Halt has recently claimed was the CIA clean up doctor.

Ed Cabansag claims that Col Halt did not coerce him into denying the incident but admitted that “They” made out it was the lighthouse beacon. Perhaps “They” were the CIA doctor and his team who debriefed some of the other airmen with their warning, bullets are cheap and what you saw was the Orford lighthouse claim.

Cabansag claims he was never interviewed by the AFOSI but Lieutenant Colonel Halt told him it was very hush-hush and advised him not to talk about it on base. We are told that the Bentwaters AFOSI, the (Air Force Office of Special Investigations) did not debrief the airmen involved but merely facilitated it.

Straight after the event Ed Cabansag was promoted to a day job but still was assigned to C Flight, perhaps so they could keep a close eye on him. Soon after the incident he was promoted to senior airman

### **They arrive back at the East gate**

Jerry Valdez, who went to East Gate to check out the situation, also remembers how the men finally showed up:

***“Burroughs and Penniston finally showed up. I somehow think something happened to them. They were acting strange. We were then told to go back to our posts.”*** [Valdez, James Easton interview]

At 04:11 am the Suffolk police are called. The time of the call is logged in the Suffolk Police log. The person at the Bentwaters law enforcement desk who made the call was Chris Arnold (Suffolk police, official log)

Arnold drives to Woodbridge to check out the situation. There he meets Burroughs at the East Gate and goes back into the woods with him:

***“I cruised out to Woodbridge after my Flight Chief said it would be okay to check it out, I met Burroughs at the East***

***Gate of Woodbridge. We left our guns with the guy riding with Burroughs and drove to the end of the long access road. We left our vehicle and walked out there.”*** [Arnold, James Easton interview]

### **British Bobbies turn up to investigate**

***“I’m certain the decision to call the local constabulary was one that was made late in the morning and with hesitation. You see no one was particularly eager to call the local police and ask silly questions about UFO’s.”*** (Arnold, James Easton interview)

The Suffolk police is informed by the Bentwaters Law Enforcement desk that unarmed troops are in the woods to investigate unusual lights in the sky, and: “we [the USAF] are terming it as a UFO at present”.

***The police contact air traffic control West Dayton and learn that reports were received of aerial phenomena over Southern England during the night. They decide to go and take a look.*** [Suffolk police official log].

Arnold also remembers meeting the Police Constables.

***“I believe we (Burroughs and I) met up with two constables who drove up in a small marked vehicle on the main road that connects to the East Gate access. I have to believe the conversation we had with them was of little consequence as I don’t recall re-entering the woods with them or spending much time chit-chatting about the issue.”*** [Arnold, James Easton interview]

***“Only lights visible from this area were from the Orford Light House. Search made of area – negative.”*** [Suffolk police, official log]

***“There was absolutely nothing in the woods. We could see lights in the distance and it appeared unusual as it was a sweeping light, (we did not know about the lighthouse on the coast at the time). We also saw some strange coloured lights in the distance but were unable to determine what they were. The lights were primarily white and were very small, far off in the distance. Occasionally one would see a shade of blue or red but I attribute that to refraction from stained glass windows in a local church in addition to the fog and weather at the time.”*** [Arnold, James Easton interview]

Arnold claims to have not seen anything unusual when he went back to the forest with Burroughs but according to Arnold he and Burroughs found three depressions on the ground of the forest floor.

***“Eventually we found three depressions in the ground, about the diameter of a coffee can in a triangular pattern. However, there was no damage to trees or scorch marks, or any damage to any plant life in the area. We noted the location of the im-***

*pressions and departed the area.” [Arnold, James Easton interview]*

One of the Police Constables that responded to the 04:11 call was Dave King. He was interviewed by Georgina who was investigating for her book “*You Cant Tell the People*”

*“We were actually on our way to visit the Bentwaters law enforcement desk when the call came through. When we arrived at the Bentwaters base we were escorted through the back gate to the east gate sentry post and were then taken to the forest by some security policemen. We had to follow their vehicle. They took us toward the spot where they said the other SP’s had gone and we were told they were still out there. We had to park the car and walk on foot. The Americans didn’t come with us. We walked about half a mile into the forest there were no Americans there, not a soul. We walked for some thirty minutes.” [Bruni, You Can’t Tell the People]*

### ***The Morning of the 26th Dec 1980***

After his encounter in the forest Sgt Penniston is sat next to Bertolino on the bus travelling back to the dorm after first turning their weapons in at the armoury. Bertolino notices that Penniston appears shook up. He could tell that something had happened to him. Bertolino is keen to know what had happened to him and Penniston tells him about his encounter in the Rendlesham forest. Penniston tells Bertolino he was glad he never took their weapons out there because if they had shot at this thing they would probably have turned into pairs of smoking boots.

*“He [Penniston] pulled out this little notebook that he used to write incidents in if he was called to an incident – he always kept notes. He pulls out the notebook and he diagrams what he saw out there. It was kind of diamond shaped with tripod legs and he explained that it wasn’t like any metal he had ever seen.”*

*“There were people there when we turned in our weapons - kaki style pants, military haircut with glasses - that took Cabansag, Longero [this probably should have been Burroughs?], and Penniston for questioning, for debriefing.” [Bertolino Earthfiles interview]*

The witnesses arrive at the shift commander’s office. Major Ed Drury was in the shift commander’s office when some of the witnesses were making their statements:

*“There was a pile of them because I recall going through them. On reading the statements I understood that it wasn’t very big [the object] but it was bigger than a mini. There were marks on the trees, quite high up and someone said they’d walked up to it [the object] and it had left depressions. I went out during the day and saw the marks on the trees and the ground depressions, which weren’t that deep, well defined and I suggested we send someone out there to do some read-*

*ings [Geiger counter readings].” [Maj Drury, Bruni, You Can’t Tell the People]*

After the bus arrives at the dorm, Bertolino’s shift is over. He later puts on his civilian clothes and goes out into the woods with a few other people. They see some security police vehicles. Captain Verrano shows them a triangular shape on the ground with circular indentations (9-10 inches across and about 4 to 5 feet apart). Verrano also shows them – using a Geiger counter - that the radiation peaks in the centre of the triangular pattern. Bertolino notices broken limbs on the trees. Later he hears that there may be other landing sites.

*“In the morning several of us were asked if we would return to the area to point out the depressions to some folks who I believe were from environmental health. They did have some type of instrument for detecting radiation and I believe they did detect some measure of radiation; however I don’t think it was a significant amount.” [Arnold, James Easton interview]*

Penniston and Burroughs were told to go to the shift Commanders office and after they were finished they went out to the site. They were surprised to find that there were already some dayshift personnel out in the area where they had their incident and wondered how they managed to find the area. They had a quick look around at the damage done to the trees and area that had the marks. The officers out there were Capt. Verrano, Master Sgt Guylas and the ops Commander Maj Drury.

*“If I remember right they were in the trees i.e. there were trees but there was a small area within the trees that they found the marks and damage to the trees.” [Burroughs, forum of Rendlesham incident site]*

The Suffolk police were called again at 10:30. They were informed that a place had been found where a craft of some sort seems to have landed, approximately 2 miles due east of East Gate. The police attended and found three marks which do not follow a set pattern. They were not impressed. They said that as UFO’s didn’t exist they were not prepared to put anything along those lines in their report. They reported in their official Suffolk police log.

*“The marks are of no depth, and could have been made by an animal” [Suffolk Police Log]*

This first night of UFO activity was to prove to be only the tip of the iceberg, over the next few days events in and around Rendlesham forest and the twin bases of Woodbridge and Bentwaters would turn even more bizarre when local civilians and military servicemen, including Deputy Base Commander Charles Halt would witness scenes that appeared straight out of a sci-fi movie.


# OUTER LIMITS MAGAZINE FIRST BIRTHDAY ISSUE

# THE HUMBERSIDE FLYING TRIANGLE OF 1987

Just recently I have been watching a few UFO documentaries that I had not seen before. One such documentary was dedicated to so-called 'flying triangles'. The documentary was made in the USA and had a variety of UFO researchers and witnesses all more or less stating that there was no way this 'huge triangular object' could have been manufactured on Earth and was unlike anything they had seen before. While watching one documentary the name of which I did not note, my thoughts went back to 1987 when me and my colleague Gary Anthony investigated the very same thing but this time the location was Humberside in East Yorkshire. I doubt anyone will have ever seen the report that Gary Anthony compiled which detailed our investigation into these sightings so I thought now might be a good time to publish this report again. At the time of the sightings in 1987 I had been an active UFO field investigator for the Yorkshire UFO Society and the Independent UFO Network in the UK and my colleague Gary Anthony had not long begun his active involvement as a field investigator. It was fortunate for Gary to have such a sighting on his doorstep (he is from Hull) when he was just getting his teeth into the subject.

**10<sup>th</sup> December 1987**

The reports of UFOs over Humberside began on the 9<sup>th</sup> of December 1987 and was brought to our attention via a local radio station called VIKING who broadcast a news item about the sightings. A later news broadcast by BBC radio Humberside revealed yet more witnesses to the events in question. A Mr Philip Readymartcher of Bilton, Hull described what he had observed the night before. My colleague Gary Anthony telephoned BBC radio Humberside and asked if they could repeat the UFO news item. They agreed and this news item was broadcast throughout the day.

Both radio stations announced that a farmer living at Fitling, Holderness had made the initial report of the UFOs and that he had reported his sighting to Humberside Police. The farmer's identity was not known to either of the radio stations as Gary Anthony had phoned them both to try and obtain more information. Gary also telephoned the local air base at RAF Binbrook. RAF Binbrook were not prepared to comment on the UFO sightings but they did stress that all their exercises had finished early on December 9<sup>th</sup>, in fact the stated that all their air activity had ceased before 4.30 pm on the 9<sup>th</sup> of December.

Two newspaper articles followed, one on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> of December 1987 in the Hull Daily Mail and another in the same newspaper on the 30<sup>th</sup> of December. Both news cuttings are included here.

I personally broadcast an appeal for witnesses on Radio Lincoln giving out a UFO HOTLINE telephone number that we

## Mystery sky sight remains a mystery

**PUZZLED** police have drawn a blank after investigating reports of a huge UFO hovering over North Humberside.

had in operation at the time. As a result, a total of over 50 witnesses who had observed the UFOs on December 9<sup>th</sup> 1987 came forward. Myself and my colleague Gary Anthony set about investigating these reports and here is a selection of what some of the eye witnesses had to say.

# Aircraft theory link in Hull 'big bang' mystery

AMERICAN pilots re-fuelling over Hull earlier this month appear to have caused a bang which triggered a number of UFO sightings.

Initially, RAF Binbrook, in Lincolnshire denied any involvement with the bang, which spurred hundreds of worried householders into contacting the emergency services.

But in a reply to a letter

from the British UFO Research Association, they now say nine US planes were involved in an exercise over Hull at the time.

Two USAF KC-135 tanker aircraft with up to seven F111's in tow from Mildenhall were operating on December 1.

BUFORA member Mr Philip Mantle who operates a UFO 'hotline' for the north, said: "Around 30 people phoned in with re-

ports of lights in the sky and formation of lights.

"We phoned RAF Binbrook at the time, but they couldn't help us. It could be we just didn't get through to the right person.

The bang sparked a number of theories, with an expert from the Royal Greenwich Observatory saying it could have been caused by a piece of space debris hurtling towards the ground.

DANSOM LANE, HULL 5.15 pm

At 5.15 pm Christine Juncar was looking across Danson Lane Recreation Ground towards the east when she observed sets of lights travelling across the sky from south to north at an elevation of 45 degrees. In her report, Mrs Juncar describes 4 or 5 sets of lights following a large main set of lights. Mrs Juncar said the lights looked like "red and white lights as bright as stars". She watched the lights for about 3 minutes until they disappeared behind buildings in the distance.

MIDDLEBURG STREET, HULL  
5.15 pm

Karen Rogers a local government officer was just arriving home from work with her boyfriend

Alan Sykes at 5.15 pm when they both saw the lights from Middleburg Street in Hull. They had just parked the car when the lights were in front of them to the east. Karen reported that she saw 3 lights at an elevation of 45 degrees and that the central

'Reports that an Unidentified Flying Object was spotted over East Hull and Holderness last night are being taken seriously by the police, who've passed them onto the government department which deals with such reported sightings.

The UFO was described as over 250 ft. long and triangular in shape was seen by a farmer flying over a farm at Fitling near Aldbrough and by several people to the east of Hull. One of them was Philip Readymartcher from Bilton: who was walking with three friends when he says he saw three objects in the sky".

This broadcast went out on every news bulletin on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> of December 1987 the day after the sightings in question

## THE EYE WITNESSES

KEYINGHAM, HOLDERNESS - 5.00 pm (approx.).

Shortly after 5.00 pm, Allison Acey, a florist in Keyingham was with two friends, Mrs M. Hook and Mrs H. Stephenson when all three observed lights in the sky. Looking in a Southerly direction towards the river Humber, they watched the lights travelling from West to East at a slow speed and at an angle of elevation of about 45 degrees. Mrs Hook said "I have never seen anything as large with such a long body and the sound was different to aeroplanes of today. It reminded me of the sound of German bombers in the last war, more like a heavy heart beat". All three ladies observed the lights for 2-3 minutes before they went out of sight in the distance.



light was white in colour and was flashing. They watched the lights for around 5 minutes before they were obscured by some buildings. The UFO travelled from south to north and a distant humming noise was heard while the objects were under observation.

BILTON, HULL 5.15 pm

Mr Philip Readymartcher, Mr C Bibby, Vanessa Bibby and Charles Bibby all observed 3 distinctive sets of lights from their garden viewpoint at High Farm, Bilton at 5.15 pm (approx.). Mr Readymartcher described the sets of lights as 3 large objects in his report, but when interviewed later by myself and Gary Anthony he stated that he could not discern any shape/s but "just saw lights". He told us that there was a smaller red light trailing behind the others, with all the lights at an elevation of 45 degrees. The 4 witnesses watched these lights for around 4 minutes flying from south to north at a height estimated by Mr Readymartcher as 2 below cloud level". The UFOs disappeared in the

distance. Mr Readymartcher and Mrs Hook also mentioned that the noise produced by these UFOs was like a large turbine engine used by large aircraft.

HOLMES LANE, BILTON,  
HULL 5.30 pm

They were driving from Coniston to Bilton when looking towards the east they spotted several UFOs. Carol Wilson stated "It had red lights on it. One object with red lights and a further red light was to the rear and above. The lights seemed to be above cloud level, very high, and we watched them travelling from south to north for 5-10 minutes until they disappeared behind cloud".

SPROATLEY, HOLDERNESS  
5.30 pm

Mrs Pauline Pindar was talking to her next-door neighbour at about 5.30 pm when her children noticed lights in the sky. Mrs Pindar, her 3 children and her neighbour all began watching the lights in the sky. In an interview Mrs Pindar told us that she was looking in an easterly direction and she described the lights as "very bright-sort of yellowish-white". The objects were seen at an elevation of 45 degrees and were travelling south to north. Mrs Pindar went on to say "They were going very gracefully, very slowly and we watched them just until they went out of sight. The second one seemed to go up on top of the third one, very closely". These lights were viewed for around 5 minutes and in her report Mrs Pindar stated that the sets of lights resembled airships.

WITHERNWICK, HORNSEA, EAST HOLDRNESS 5.30 pm.

Michael Harrison, an amateur astronomer, was looking east (towards the North Seas coast) out of his bedroom window at 5.30 pm (approx.) when he saw the lights. He describes 4 red lights in a row, with a white light leading and one trailing behind in his report. Per Michaels estimate the lights were below cloud level at an elevation of 45 degrees travelling south to north at a slow speed. Michael stated that in comparison some of lights were as bright as at the Canis Majoris star Sirius. He could also hear a 2low pitched noise like the sound a large engine would make". Michael Harrison saw these lights for a duration of 3 minutes before they disappeared in to the distance and tat he could still hear the noise after they had gone. He added the noise "changed to a sound like thunder".

Mr John Taylor a farmer stated "I was chopping wood in the outer house to start off with, to light a fire. It was somewhere around tea time. dustrial estates of Grimsby” at an elevation of 45 degrees. Mr White added that the lights travelled from west to east and had a ‘haze’ around them. “There were two objects and the second was following the first and they veered off to fly over the River Humber” he added. Mr White estimated that the lights were about 2 miles away from him and he watched them for 5 minutes before they disappeared in the distance.

### THE INVESTIGATION

In 1987 if you were a UFO field investigator then there was only 3 different ways to obtain information from either witnesses or officialdom and they were in writing, on the telephone or in person. There was no internet and of course no email. My colleague Gary Anthony and I used all 3 options open to us at the time. The first option was to send out official UFO sighting report forms which we did. We also contacted several agencies via post such as the police and the Ministry of Defence. And of

course, we interviewed in person a number of the witnesses. From the very beginning when I was on Radio Lincoln I was provided with information that was not broadcast on air. Remember, the object in question right from the beginning was described as an enormous ‘triangular object’ moving as slowly as 30 mph. Remember also the UFO documentary that I had watched in 2017 on which all the UFO researchers stated that such huge triangular objects could not be made on Earth. Well I hate to say this but I think they are wrong.

Having been a UFO field investigator since 1980 which is long before the age of the internet my experience in investigating such sightings has been invaluable. It is my opinion which is based on that experience that when you have many sightings on the same day across a wide area then there is always a natural explanation to them even if you cannot find it. This is not a scientific formula it is instead just simply experience and nothing more. You may ‘if’ and ‘but’ all you like as I’m sure some of you will, but this is how I see it.

The solution to the sightings over Humberside were given to me while I was on Radio Lincoln. One of those calling in was a former RAF Officer. He told me that he thought that what was being reported was an RAF refuelling exercise. I had no reason to believe or disbelieve this gentleman but to his explanation and my experience suggested to me right away that he may well be correct. However, you cannot just accept such a thing at face value; instead you must do your research.

Our first port of call was Humberside Police. In a letter dated

16<sup>th</sup> of December 1987 they stated:


BBC Radio Humberside had contacted the RAF base at Binbrook at the time of the sightings and they simply confirmed that it was nothing to do with them. Armed with a possible explanation for these events I wrote to them and had a reply dated 18<sup>th</sup> December 1987.

Dear Mr Mantle

### ALLEGED UFO SIGHTINGS – 9 December 1987

1. Thank you for your enquiry about alleged UFO sightings at around 1730 hours on December 9<sup>th</sup>. We also received 4 or 5 telephone enquiries at that time: no enquiry telephone numbers were recorded though one call was understood to be from the postmaster at Great Limber near Grimsby.

2. We made appropriate enquiries at the time and were eventu-



ally satisfied that the reports concerned 2 USAF KC 135 tanker aircraft each with up to 7 F111 aircraft in trail: these aircraft from Mildenhall were operating with Midland Radar and the area at the times of the reports.

I hope this information is of use to you.

To further confirm that it was a USAF refuelling exercise from RAF Mildenhall I wrote to the Ministry of Defence. I had a reply from them dated 14<sup>th</sup> January 1988.

Dear Mr Mantle

Thank you for your letter of 19 December 1987 which asked if we possessed any information relating to sightings seen in the Humberside area on 9 December 1987. I have now spoken to Royal Air Force and can confirm that your suspicions about the sightings being a refuelling exercise were correct. On that particular evening, it is highly likely that the objects seen by your witnesses were USAF KC135 and F111 aircraft which were exercising over the North Sea, passing over Humberside at about 5.00 pm.

of whom describe a huge triangular object moving at a mere 30 miles per hour can have a rational explanation after all. I know there will be those reading this saying 'yes, you solved that case, but this one is different'. I can hear it now but it is not different. In my experience when you have a lot of sightings on the same day in roughly the same area there will be a rational explanation for it whether you can find it or not. With the sightings in Humberside in 1987 there were even several witnesses to the events who would not believe us when we presented them with the evidence. The will to believe is very strong. There will be others who waffle on about a cover-up and you can't trust the RAF, the Police or the MoD. Of course, they will have nothing to substantiate such conspiracy theories. It could well be that many UFO magazines will not publish this article listing it as of little importance. Well that's up to the editors of course but it will not surprise you to know that I would disagree

with them.

A lot of today's UFO researchers have learnt their trade online and in the virtual world and in some respects, I feel sorry for them. I am thankful that I learnt my trade long before the internet ever existed and the experience I gained from it are still invaluable today.

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# INTELLIGENT LIGHT FORMS AND THE FIRE-FOG

On Thursday the 19.1.17 I met up with a few of the trawler men on Bridlington harbour. I received a phone call from a boat owner a few days before asking me if I would take a few pictures of them. They wanted some images as they worked on their boat in the harbour. I am always happy to help if I can; they are a wealth of information to me so it was the least I could do. Many of the things that happen out at sea never reach the ears of people on land. Partly because the men just don't talk about work outside of their close knit community, if it does not involve catching fish it simply does not interest them. The following story is one such example I was told the morning I arrived to take pictures for Danny and his father who own the trawler called Hetty Jane. When I arrived they were busy repairing lobster pots ready for the next trip to sea. The North Sea is hard on equipment and the men who work it but they are accustomed to the harsh environment and ready for whatever it throws at them. Over the years we have become great friends and they are always happy to see me and share interesting bits of information. This is how the conversation went.


Danny

***"Have you told Paul about that weird fog that people reported the other day."***

My ears pricked up soon as I heard the word weird, not sure how that reads. Must mean I'm a bit weird. The two men stood with Danny glanced up but said nothing; they just carried on weaving thick green nylon cord in and out of the sea battered lobster pots like blind men reading brail. Danny continued.

***"Well it was probably nothing really Paul but it came over the radio that all boats in the area had to look out for a bank of red or Orange fog. It was a new one on us, no one seemed to have any idea what caused it. It was reported to be about three and a half miles off Withernsea."***

Danny and his dad had not heard anything like this before, his dad said a call came over the radio to say someone had also seen blue fog. But that was the only mention of blue fog he heard. At the time they suspected someone had let distress flares off but there was no mention that was the case. Various radio messages were exchanged by the trawler men but no problems were reported. That was all Danny and his father could tell me about the red fog, but at the back of my mind I seemed to think I had heard or read something similar before.



They said the sea was calm and apart from radio exchanges about the red fog no one seemed too concerned. Danny said it was later confirmed that the fog was not thought to be from a flare but I wanted to be sure.

The next day I decided to pay a visit to the lifeboat station, I wanted to find out if any boats had been reported to be in distress and released flares on the day in question. Something told me there might be a little more to learn about the red fog and I still had it in the back of my mind that I had heard something similar before. I arrived at the station at about 10 am; I had a donation cheque to drop off. Monies from a funeral collection some months before so it was a good opportunity to discuss the red fog. I asked if there had been any interesting call outs or reports. The guy at the station told me a call came over the radio at 8am on the 16.1.17 that was a bit of a strange one, no one had any clue as to what it was or what could have caused it?

I explained that I had already been told about it by a few of the men on the harbour and that was my reason for coming.

He said it was just a request to be on the lookout for orange lights, he did not say who or where from but orange lights had been seen out at sea.

This was even more interesting, the trawler men made no men-

tion of any orange lights out at sea. I wanted to know about reports of red fog? I asked if he was aware of the red fog that had been seen.

Paul

*"I see I did not realise lights had been seen as well, Danny and his dad told me it came over the radio that boats had to look for a bank of red fog."*

RNLI

*"Yes that's right there was reports of a thick red mist or fog that was being seen off Withernsea by a few fishing vessels. But orange lights had also been seen in the sky that morning. But the fog was not thought to be from the lights and no boats radioed in to say they were in trouble."*

That was all I could gather from the RNLI, the orange lights were a new addition that Danny and his dad had either missed or forgot to tell me about. I think that many things happen at sea that are never spoken about. I truly believe the small amount of information I manage to gather is just the surface of a much deeper pool.

From the lifeboat station I headed on foot to the archive at Bridlington library, in the back of my mind I had some vague recollection of seeing a news paper article from the 1980s that talked of a red fog. As usual I had my note book with me so once at the library I scanned its pages to see if I had made any reference to red fog. Luckily I had made a one line entry titled Fire fog and the name Mary Sexton; it was from the Bridlington Free press dated March the 12<sup>th</sup> 1987. Ten minutes later the reel of tap was on the machine and I arrived at the date and began to read.

## Flares but lifeboat draws blank

Bridlington lifeboat searched during the night after a report of red flares at sea. They found nothing and returned at 3 a.m. yesterday morning. This is the fifth report of such flares along the North East Coast in the past fortnight, and lifeboats have found nothing.

Theories being considered are that flares have been stolen and are being let off; or that people are mistaking meteorites or lightning for flares in misty conditions.

The first recorded rain for some weeks fell on Bridlington yesterday at the end of 24 hours two-hundredths of an inch of rain had been recorded, and is believed to have been the result of dense fog and heavy dew.

### FIRE FOG CLIPPING

And have to admit I only took an interest in the strange red fog because I wondered if I would find any similarities; the report could have been the start of a sequence of events.

Events I first noted in my book Truth Proof, one unusual event seems to act like a trip wire and what follows are whole series of equally strange occurrences. The red fog could have been piece of the puzzle that had gone unnoticed.

With the date now confirmed as 1987 I began to read the news from thirty years ago. I hoped it might offer clues that could be linked to what was happening now in real time. However remote the chances of that being the case I had to check. To get a full picture of 1987 I would have to read all of the year. I need-

ed to know if anything unexplained had happened before or after March of that year that could tie in with the strange fire fog reported by Mary Sexton. If it had then it might have been possible to document a similar pattern unfolding as I sit here now typing in real time, I was literally chasing smoke. When I spoke with Danny and his father later in the week they told me that they knew nothing about any reports of Orange lights. They said they had spoken with other fishermen who all thought it was not the type of smoke associated with a flare, adding that it was a thick bank of red fog that blanketed a large area of the sea. They also said a Blue fog had been talked about, the lifeboat station made no reference to blue fog. I asked them if anyone reported smelling anything whilst in the red fog. If it was flares the smoke they produce smells and tastes foul, as far as they were aware no one said they could smell or taste anything in the air. That was backed up by the member of staff at the RNLI who did not think the fog had anything to do with flairs. The light-form activity off Bempton and Speeton has been particularly interesting over the past month or so with many rock anglers reporting seeing the orange spheres on numerous occasions.

For readers of OLM not familiar with the term light forms or ILFs. I used it when talking about the Orange and red spheres of light seen off the coast and around the East Yorkshire Wolds. Reference my old web site ILF-UFO, meaning Intelligent Light Forms. That is where the term originates from.

We have been documenting the light forms for many years, out at sea and over the Wolds. I even managed filmed them on more than one occasion this year, I can say with confidence that what we saw was not flares. It could be that the red fog has no connection to anything unusual; I may not even be around the next time it is reported. Not if a thirty year gap between sightings is the norm.

There are key points that stand in the way of this Fog being just a normal run of the mill weather phenomena. Coast guard considered it to be of sufficient interest that a call was put out to all boats in the vicinity to look out for the red fog. The member of Staff at the life-boat station said he heard the call come over the radio and there was talk of orange lights seen out at sea around the same time. No one reported hearing any noise that would suggest the discharge of flares; no boats were reported in distress. It all seems a bit vague in that no can say with any certainty what it was that caused it. My visit to the archive however did reveal a few more interesting bits of activity around the time the fire fog was reported in 1987. It would appear red lights had been seen out at sea around the Danes Dyke area on several occasions. The lights were thought to be distress flares, however no boats were ever reported to be in any difficulty. I later found out through word of mouth that it was named fire fog because it appeared to bristle and sparkle. When Mary Sexton encountered it driving back home to Flamborough in 1987 it covered a large area and was far too dense to be from any flare. She encountered it inland close to Flamborough, a few

miles away from Danes Dyke and Sewerby. Another thing I noticed was that her report was in the Bridlington free press dated Thursday the 12<sup>th</sup> of March and the article said she encountered the fire fog on the previous Wednesday which would have been the 4<sup>th</sup>. The article also says the Bridlington life boat was launched at about the same time as Mary encountered the fog after a report of a red distress [red light] flare off Sewerby. A search of Sewerby and Danes Dyke beaches found nothing. I find it hard to believe the reported fire fog was anything connected to a distress flare when you consider Mary Sexton ran into the fog at church lane in Flamborough, a distance of two and a half miles away from Sewerby. With this in mind I was back at the RNLI a few days later, I now had some dates from 1987 and I hoped that life boat logs from that time may offer more clues. As expected we found a log entry for March the 4<sup>th</sup> 1987. The times Mary Sexton reported running into the fire fog and the time the lifeboat was launched were out by one and a quarter hours. This suggests the fire fog was present before the red distress signal [red light] was seen. Bridlington lifeboat launched at 20.16 and returned at 22.10, nothing was found. There was another call out to a suspected flare [red light] on the 25<sup>th</sup> of March at 11.30pm but the boat was not put to sea. The lights were reported off shore around the Sewerby and Danes Dyke areas. These examples of lights seen off the coast are only a fraction of what has been seen and reported over the years. Even seasoned lifeboat men and trawler men are now starting to realise there could be more to these lights, lights that have gone under the radar for such a long time. Up until this point no one has ever bothered to gather the information and lay it bare. The amount of call outs and reports from the public and fishing boats about these orange and red phantoms off our coast is staggering. I suspect East and North Yorkshire are not alone when it comes to phenomena of this kind.

Not everything that surrounds the subject of UFOs has to involve the words space ships and flying saucers. This high strangeness hits from all levels leaving little or no evidence that it ever existed.


Reports of the lightforms span decades and it is clear after reading the explanations offered up by professional bodies that in many instances they have no idea what was actually seen. It is not unusual to read or hear three or four different theories for one sighting out at sea. Off the shelf explanations such as unexplained weather phenomena, Meteors, ball lightning and the new and widely used Chinese lanterns are all offered up. The reason they get away with this is because these explanations fit with what people know and understand.

Intelligent Light Foams [ILFs] are not just the occupants of our dreams, they are real, we just do not possess the tools or vocabulary to explain them.

## THE GARTMORN ROAD POLTERGEIST.

**Location: Sauchie, Clackmannanshire Central Scotland.**

**Date: (February to March 1987)**

(I'm taking another case from our files of our society; this case comes from the town of Sauchie in Clackmannanshire Central Scotland and occurred back in 1987. Fellow researcher Ron Halliday and I began our research into claims that three houses joined together in Gartmorn Road Sauchie, a town near Alloa were haunted. Early research showed that these houses which were built around 1937 were, for the past six months, were subject to strange footsteps, noises, bangs, smells, and all the usual phenomenon associated with haunted buildings. Many of these noises it must be said were reported to have come from the loft. Interviews were conducted on audio tape with Cindy Hope (pseudonym) where she told me that ever since she had first moved into the property she just didn't feel at home, that there was something not quite right about it. Cindy's first experience was that of standing on a certain stair on the staircase in which she experienced strange sensations, dizziness being the main one. Cindy's 18 year old daughter Laura (pseudonym) had to sleep with the light on owing to constant bad dreams. Cindy's next door neighbour Mrs Elaine Peters also related much of the same events only these events were happening to her in her own home! Again with most of the noises coming from the loft area.

## THE INVESTIGATION BEGINS

SPI consulted Tony Cornell of Cambridge University, and Professor Archie Roy of Glasgow University asking them if they could offer any form of assistance, unfortunately they were both too tied up with other commitments to be able to offer any help. SPI also contacted other Scottish researchers but again with little effect. So, it looked like we were on our own with

this one. And so our society, Strange Phenomena Investigations, SPI began one of our most intriguing cases that we would talk about for a very long time.

When our Investigative team appeared on the scene we found much to our surprise that the two families who lived at either side of Cindy's house, had had enough of the ghostly events that were happening in their house, they abandoned their houses and joined up with Cindy who lived in the middle house of the three. And when we walked into Cindy's house, well it was like a battle zone. There were camp beds and air beds everywhere in the living room where the two guest families had come to stay (strength in numbers as they say) Apparently what had capped it all off was when Cindy's neighbours had come round to visit and they were all sitting in the living room discussing all the weird events when all of a sudden the sound of '*thumping*' coming from upstairs, probably from the loft again they surmised. That was it, enough was enough, sick to the back teeth of these disturbances, they decided to face their fears and they all got up out of their chairs and angrily headed out into the hall area and looked up the stairs. Their fears

were doubly enhanced for when they all looked up the empty stairs they all clearly heard the unmistakable sound of heavy footsteps coming towards them, and nobody, **absolutely nobody, was there.** Needless to say, they broke all speed records as they quickly took to their heels jamming themselves in a door as they all tried to get out there at the same time. That was the last straw Cindy said, that's when her next door neighbours on both sides joined forces with them. Since our last communications with the family, stranger events had occurred, the following is a combination of them.



Cold spots would suddenly appear in various parts of the house even in summer.

Many strange noises came from the loft.

A kitchen drawer opened by itself and a knife and fork sailed through mid air without anyone touching them and then they both fell to the floor, thankfully without injuring anyone.

The family dog (of the Hope family) refused to go upstairs, and anytime anyone tried to lead it upstairs it would bite the hand off you. One day it was found in an 'upstairs' bedroom locked in (from the inside!!!!) The dog had tried to claw its way through the door and had bloodied its paws in the attempt. The bedroom door was full of scratches.

A doppelganger of one of the woman was scene to walk down the stairs but that particular lady was not in the house at that time. (More of that one in a moment)

During one point in our Investigation as we were interviewing one of the ladies, she went into a trance and started speaking in a different language which no one had heard before. I was sitting right in front of this lady and I can tell you, this was pretty scary.

Mrs Peter's 11 year old son Dane claimed that he was being visited in the night by a strange man and woman, the woman

was carrying a small baby in her arms. Both people he said, looked real and solid. On one occasion the ghostly woman snatched the pillow beneath the head of young Dane and placed it at the bottom of the bed! Not only that, this woman continually asked young Dane what his name was and also asked him not to be frightened of them. She went on to say that they didn't like the dog next door and it was her that locked the dog in the room so that it wouldn't bite us or the baby. (*Ghosts being frightened of earthly dogs, whatever next?*) We ascertained that young Dane was 'NOT' aware that the dog was found locked inside the bedroom.

When I happened to mention to Dane's mother about her son's visitors in the night, the man and woman holding the baby, she blurted out, "*That would explain it I've had strange dreams of a man and woman with a baby*". Elaine Peters, the next door neighbour later explained that she has lost two babies in childbirth. On a later date, young Dane said to us that he was still seeing the strange man and woman appear in his bedroom and this time they had said to him that they were only 'looking after the baby' until the owners stopped being mad at it? Dane said that the woman kept trying to insert a strange looking dummy tit into the baby's mouth as she turned round and headed towards his mum's room. Was this all fantasy in the mind of a young boy who must surely have been aware of what his fami-

ly and friends had been speaking about for days? Well that's a possibility that we have to consider, but then again, what if it 'is true'. Just because something sounds ridiculous does not necessarily mean that it is so.

Now with any haunted house we have to be very careful, careful in the sense that it might not be haunted at all? That it all might be either one big joke for ego publicity, or, more realistically, it may be that the occupants want to get out of the house in order to get a better house, (believe you me some people will try anything in order to get better housing, although admittedly, we as a research team, have never come across this before.) But as with any case, we still had to ascertain for sure, whether or not this was a genuine haunting or just some people out to pull the wool over our eyes. We needn't have worried on that point, as later events would clearly show us that this case was the 'real deal'. As the investigation continued we also found out from Cindy that one day as she walked into the kitchen, she heard a distinct 'swishing' sound come from above the kitchen table, a sound that she couldn't account for. It wasn't long before electrical items were switching themselves on and off, televisions, radios. Elaine explained to the author that one of the most unnerving episodes that she herself witnessed was the day when she saw the reflection of a man's face in the stacking stereo system. This wasn't a reflection from the TV as it wasn't switched on at the time nor was it a reflection of anyone else in the room for there was only her and her small son in the room at the time. She did not recognise this face at all. Marie Hope (Cindy's daughter) stated to our society that on one occasion when her boyfriend paid a visit, he claimed to have heard Marie's voice calling him to come upstairs (he had only just come into the house) whereupon he did so but upon entering Marie's bedroom she wasn't there, he found her fast asleep downstairs on the living room settee. Further to this, along the same lines, Cindy herself heard her 21 year old son Timmy calling out to her, but Timmy wasn't home. This 'mimicking' of voices is not that uncommon in hauntings and is reported quite often. It would appear that spirits get quite a kick of pretending to be someone they are not!

## THE GARTMORN ROAD POLTERGEIST.

(Part 2)

**Date: (February to March 1987)**

We continue with our report into our society's research into a poltergeist case that affected 3 houses joined together in the town of Sauchie (pronounced Saw-Kay) near the town of Alloa in Clackmannanshire Central Scotland. We now learn of the local Alloa Christian Spiritualist Church involvement with this case.

Probably one of the strangest things that occurred in Cindy's house was the day when Cindy's mother happened to spend the night. The mother was downstairs in the kitchen making a cup of tea when she saw her daughter Cindy walk down the stairs in a flowered night gown. She asked her daughter as she was descending the stairs if she would like a cup of tea to which her daughter did not respond, indeed the daughter coming down the stairs, stopped, then turned round and went back up the stairs. Later the daughter came back downstairs to which her mother said, "*Hey, why did you not answer me when you were coming down the stairs*"? Cindy replied, "*But I'm just up, I just got up this second*". Cindy's mother went on to mention her daughter's night gown to which Cindy replied, "*But mum, I haven't got a night gown like that, I don't own one like that*". So we have to ask ourselves, if that wasn't Cindy coming down the stairs, then who was it! We've heard of Doppelgangers which is someone that looks exactly like you and has been known to disappear, was that the case here? Was Cindy just sleepwalking and didn't know it, but if so, where did the night gown come from if she states that she doesn't own one? We also learned in our Investigation that strange 'growling' noises were heard coming from a cupboard in Cindy's home, a noise that she never investigated.

### SPI SPEND THE NIGHT

After taking notes of all the recent strange occurrences, I asked Cindy if we (SPI) could spend the night in the family home to see if we could document these effects ourselves, this request was accepted and so my colleague Kevin Cole and I arranged to spend the night there the following evening. Upon entering the



property, Kevin and I began to set up our equipment. We were all alone in the house as the Hope family had gone next door to be with the Peters family and the other family to give us free reign of her property. We decided to set up most of the equipment in Marie's bedroom which we were told, was the chilliest room in the whole house (even in the summer) But before Kevin and I sat down for our night time vigil we decided to check the loft space of both Cindy and Elaine's house. So with some trepidation we gingerly entered the Cindy's loft and that was spooky I can tell you. (We Investigators are no heroes I can tell you!) And with our flashlights we looked in every nook and cranny. We didn't find any hidden devices that could make these banging noises, nor did we find any birds' nests that could account for birds getting in to the loft and making noises. We also never found any evidence of any mice or rats which could have made scurrying sounds in the loft which might have been misconstrued as something else. It was just an ordinary loft which contained the usual bits and bobs of household junk. Satisfied, we quickly (and I mean quickly!) got out of the loft and went next door to do the same in Elaine's loft.

Sadly we didn't see, hear or sense a thing on that particular night which I must admit was most disappointing. In the morning, we were joined again by all three families where they were disappointed to learn that we hadn't seen anything. (They were probably not as disappointed as us)

### **THE EMPTY AND LOCKED ROOM**

I then took the decision to take the Hope family and some members of the other families, along to my local Spiritualist

Church in Alloa to see if they could help. The Alloa Christian Spiritualist Church meetings are held in an upper room in the Alloa Town Hall. (I must state that I gave the Church committee members minimal details about what was going on as I was hoping that at a later date we could perhaps get some of their psychics to attend the houses). I had to leave later that night as I was working at the local Glassworks which was a bit of a pain but there you go.

The following day I took a phone call at home from one of the ladies of the church who stated excitedly to me that 10 minutes after I had gone, loud banging noises could be heard coming from above their heads. They

knew that above their heads was a locked room so they all got up out of their seats went upstairs and peered through the two oblong windows of the door into the locked room. Everything was in order, there was nobody there. The noises had stopped. They tried the door handle, it was securely locked. They all then trooped off back downstairs, sat in their seats, and no sooner had they done so then all hell let loose again, banging's and thumps coming from above their head. There were also sounds like falling stones falling down between the walls of the building.

They jumped up off their seats and raced upstairs only to be met with the same sight, a locked room and nobody there. The family explained to the church committee people that this was nothing unusual these types of crashes and bangs were a regular occurrence in the family home. The committee members stated to the family that nothing like this had ever occurred in the Alloa Christian Spiritualist Church before whereupon Cindy smiled and stated, "*Well this type of thing goes on all the time back at our house*".

In our next and concluding part of this amazing poltergeist case, the case takes a new and unexpected twist which see's Malcolm also being assaulted!

# THE GARTMORN ROAD POLTERGEIST.

## (Part 3)

**Date: (February to March 1987)**

In our concluding part of this disturbing poltergeist case we learn how the case came to its conclusion and how it's sometimes better 'not' to be a paranormal Investigator!

Having convinced the Alloa Christian Spiritualist Church of the seriousness of this case, some church members along with some SPI members attended the Hope house to see what they could do (16<sup>th</sup> February 1987) The following information is taken from notes that I took of this Investigation at that time.

After some brief introductions as to what the Alloa Church did and what we hoped to achieve by them being there, we separated into groups, some went upstairs and some downstairs. Prayers were said in each of these rooms by mediums of the church. Audio recordings were taken by me of these prayers John Allardice a local medium, stated that he felt extreme heaviness in his head and also heat throughout his body. Mr Allardice then said that he perceived a voice which was asking for love. He then got two spirit people come through saying that they 'didn't want to be sent away'! Now I was at this time in Marie's bedroom in which local Alloa medium Emily Manini was saying some prayers. I remember that the whole room was bitterly cold, but it was February after all. But I do recall that my teeth were clattering quite loudly as I shivered in this room, (which was a wee bit embarrassing) Anyway, after Emily had finished saying her prayer, the silence in the room was broken by the sound of a woman bounding up the stairs shouting at the top of her voice that Cindy had been pushed off a wooden bench in the living room with nobody hear her.

Elaine Peters who was in the bedroom with me, stated that just before this woman came bounding up the stairs; she felt that the room was getting warmer as if whatever might have been in the room with us, had left and went elsewhere, downstairs perhaps! We all at once quickly abandoned the bedroom and rushed downstairs. After the excitement of what previously had happened, a church member administered psychic healing to Cindy, Elaine and the other neighbour. All was quite for now and

the relaxed psychic healing seemed to ease the tense situation. Now this is where I made a big mistake. I stupidly turned off the audio tape recorder.

For some minutes later the most strange and alarming look came over Elaine Peters face. A menacing piercing look in which one felt they had to turn away from, I know I certainly did? Suddenly, Elaine stood up and started speaking out in the most strangest voice. Definitely unlike her own. From my notes, and sadly not from my audio tape, this is what Elaine said.

*"They took Lawrence away, they threw him down a hole, threw logs over him". "I like it here, I don't want to go". "They keep taking away my friends, my mum's name is Victoria, men are going to get me, the men that threw Lawrence down the hole". "They said that he was dead, we are not dead". "Elona is the name of the baby, Lawrence is 30 now, I'm 25, I can't look around the room because the men will get me. Please don't let me go away" "If mummy comes they'll put her down the hole" "I've got spots but she and Lawrence can't be dead because of this baby".*

I would point out to you the reader that the name Elona was the name of a baby that Elaine had lost in childbirth some four years previously. Incidentally, the girl's name **Elona** *\e-lo-na\* is a variant of **Alona** (Hebrew) and **Ilona** (Hungarian, Greek), and the meaning of Elona is "oak tree; light". All eyes were fixed on Elaine as she continued to whirl about the room and speak out in this strange manner; it surely was one of the strangest sights that I've seen in all my years of 'ghost busting'. Eventually, after about five minutes, Elaine slumped down into a nearby chair. Wow, this was something else and totally unexpected too.

All of which not captured on audio tape, I could have kicked myself. The hole that Elaine spoke about bothered me. I was aware that quite near this housing scheme was a number of old mine shafts (now bricked up) At a later date myself and a fellow investigator visited some of these mine shafts, and although we couldn't gain access, we took a number of photographs of them. Of course, these mine shafts might have had nothing at all to do with what Elaine was speaking about when she was 'taken over' (if indeed taken over she was!) Could these 'holes' that Elaine referred to be anything to do with

plague pits? A number of plagues spread throughout Central Scotland hundreds of years ago could this have a bearing on what she was referring to? The following day SPI secured the services of a well know Stirling medium, Mrs Jean Glenn. Jean visited the homes of the families concerned but other than her picking up some strong psychic impressions from the homes, nothing else was ascertained. On the 18<sup>th</sup> of February a colleague and I were again given permission to spend the night in the house. We did all the usual checks from the loft through to every room in the house, all seemed in proper order. I recall sitting on the top stair of the stairs in the house in total darkness that is for a faint moonlight beam which tumbled through a chink in the curtain of the top landing window casting its soft glow at the bottom of the stairs. Dust particles caught in the beam danced around and all was quiet in the house. It was at this point that I thought to myself, *"why do I do this, I very rarely see anything in haunted houses it always happens when I'm not there"*. I moved the quilt which was around my shoulders closer to my face as the cold still air bit all around me. For the second time SPI had experienced nothing in the house, to which again all family members couldn't believe, indeed they were quite angry that we hadn't experienced anything, I couldn't believe it. None the less, we kept our eyes and ears on the situation as the days rolled by. One amusing incident that occurred during this Investigation (well its amusing now it certainly wasn't at the time) was the following.

#### **ASSAULTED ON AN INVESTIGATION!**

I was sitting having a quite drink with a friend in the Royal Oak bar in Alloa when this bloke comes up to me and grabs me by the throat. Now he was seriously pissed off BIG TIME. I hadn't a clue who this guy was, I had never seen him before in my life, and by way of introducing himself, he had me by the throat, pinned to the wall, and honestly my feet were dangling in mid air. It was seriously like a Tom & Jerry cartoon. I tried to speak but I couldn't, he was compressing my wind pipe. He then said, (And I'm being extremely conservative here) *"I'm going to kill you, you're the guy that's seeing my girl"*. Not quite what he said, but this is a family book! Now, like I say, I don't know who this chap was but he's angrier than a grizzly bear whose meal has been taken away from him. Eventually I managed to ease out a few words in my mid air dilemma. I asked him who he was on about and he stated that I had been





seeing Cindy Hope his ex girlfriend who lives (*He gave me the house number and street at this point*) Gartmorn Road Sauchie. Now this was beginning to make sense but he clearly had the wrong end of the stick. I said that I was a paranormal researcher and I was Investigating the claims made to us by Mrs Harrison and that I was attending her house in a research capacity, he thundered by saying, *"Well I've heard a lot of good lines in my time but you mate take the biscuit, a paranormal researcher, are you taking the mick" ?* I informed him that I wasn't taking the mick and I could prove who I was with my SPI card and he could also check it with his. Eventually as I told him more about myself and the other people who were involved in the case, he released his grip. I fell to the floor like a sack of potatoes. If I had have been watching this I would have been in hysterics, but there you are, that's a true story of my one and only time (so far!) of almost getting beaten up in the line of his paranormal duties. As I say, I can laugh about it now, but I Certainly couldn't at the time. The outcome of this Investigation was that we later on conducted a 'cleansing ceremony' in the house where our resident psychic Helen Walters and other members of SPI made contact with those spirit entities that were 'occupying' the house and made sure that they went to the light. We hope that it worked. All families moved away from the district soon after and I couldn't really knock on the new tenants door and say, *"Excuse me, but your house used to be haunted, can you tell me if it still is"*? I don't think that would have gone down so well. All in all then, this was a most interesting case, and although we researchers never saw or heard anything unusual ourselves, (Apart from Elaine's strange trance like state) it was nonetheless an interesting experience for us all.

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## Occam's Razor

"Simpler explanations are, other things being equal, generally better than more complex ones"

## Introduction

In 1979 a strange encounter with a "UFO" in a Scottish woodland area was reported to the press. A forester by the Name of Robert (Bob) Taylor had a strange experience which defied any logical explanation and was deemed serious enough to warrant a full investigation by the Police Force.

In Dechmont Law Woods an area close to a town called Livingston, the forester had a strange encounter which to this day has never been satisfactorily explained.

(Dechmont Law is located in Central Scotland 15 Miles from the West of Edinburgh and adjacent to the M8 motorway which connects Edinburgh to Glasgow, two of Scotland's largest cities)

This book sets out in detail, a precise description of all of the events that happened that day then goes on to examine the various explanations that have been offered up to explain the unusual occurrence. Finally, after much research and investigation this book reveals the only logical conclusion that makes sense and explains every detail of the incident.

The "Dechmont Law Encounter" (as it has become known) is the only known case of a UFO investigation to have been investigated by the police in Scotland that remains (at the time of writing) an unsolved case. I believe that the final explanation offered up in this book effectively solves this case.

Even Robert Taylor was unaware of the true cause of his encounter and he went to his grave never truly understanding what had actually occurred to him on that Autumn day on the ninth of November 1979 .

## Part 1 – Robert Taylor's Incredible Story - In Full

This story has been covered many times over the thirty plus years since this incident first occurred. Inevitably, many of the reports that have been written about it on the internet and in magazines and books are second hand accounts that will have the authors own "spin" on the events that occurred.

Therefore, In order to get the "purest" account of what happened that day, I would like to relay to you, the original press report that was published at the time.

What follows is a transcript of the original account given at a press conference a few days after the event took place:-

### My Brush With The Aliens

A man relived this week his encounter in a Livingston wood with "robot-like creatures from a strange craft". Bob Taylor told how the encounter left him shocked, dazed and unable to speak. He described how he discovered a large dome-shaped machine in a secluded clearing in Dechmont Law wood.

Mr. Taylor revealed his tale of the fantastic to a press conference on Monday.

On Friday morning (November 9<sup>th</sup> 1979) 61 – year old Mr. Taylor was working in the woods at Dechmont Law, below Deer Hill, only a few hundred yards from the M8 motorway.

At around 10.20am he walked into a clearing where he was confronted by a large dull grey dome-shaped craft. "Around it was a flange and there were propellers sticking out"

(Authors Note – Robert Taylor later also described the surface of the object as having a rough texture similar to that of sandpaper)


In calm and measured tones, Mr. Taylor told incredulous newspaper-men how the machine seemed to be merging into its surrounding.

“It seemed as if it was camouflaging itself”, he said.

Mr. Taylor was alone in the woods except for his Irish setter, Lara. He had parked his LDC Forestry Department van quite some distance

away from the clearing.

As he gazed down at the silent unmarked craft in the hollows, two spheres came from beneath it.

“They looked like naval mines, about four to five foot high, with six stalks coming from each one.”

“I was mesmerised as I watched”, said the foreman forester.

**But Mr. Taylor’s memory of what happened after they closed on him is hazy.**

As they rolled towards him on the stalks the only noise he heard was a sucking sound as they crossed the damp grass. He was overpowered by a very strong smell.

“I could hardly breathe. The smell caught the back of my

throat,” he said.

“Then I must have fainted or been knocked out by the smell”.

He assumes the robots must have grabbed him because when he came round his trousers were torn at the side of his legs.

Mr. Taylor could not recall with accuracy his emotions during those incredible minutes of Friday morning.

But he is certain there wasn’t any menace from the craft or the two machines which approached him.

One thing he remembers as he was suffering from the effects of the powerful odour was Lara barking.

“Lara may have frightened the machines off or perhaps unnerved them, I don’t know,” he said.

When he came round he found the clearing was empty. Dazed shocked and unable to speak, he half crawled, half staggered to his van.

But the effects of the encounter had left him unable to drive or use the van’s two-way radio.


He crawled and stumbled the mile-and-a-half to his home.

His wife Mary thought he had a serious accident when he staggered into his house at 4 Broomieknowe Drive, Livingston Station.

She telephoned his boss, Mr. Malcolm Drummond, head of the Livingston Development Corporation Forestry Department.

Mrs. Taylor and Mr. Drummond were skeptical of his tale of the close encounter in the woods but Mr. Taylor insisted.

He persuaded Mr. Drummond to accompany him to the spot



This Image: Photo of one of the tears in his clothing.




This Image: Photo of one of the tears in the corresponding trouser leg

Until then he hadn't believed in flying saucers and UFO's

"I've never read science fiction and I don't pay much attention to it on television."

"But I definitely believe in them now", said Mr. Taylor.

Mr. Gordon Fraser of the British UFO Research Association said Mr. Taylor's account was similar in many respect to other reports of encounters with UFOs.

A senior police officer said the tracks in the woods had been photographed. The matter was being treated seriously and reports have been forwarded to Lothian and Borders Police HQ in Edinburgh.

End of press report.

Authors Note

In order to try and build a complete picture of what actually happened that day, what follows is a summary of accounts of events as described in Wikipedia. I believe this account may (in addition to providing additional information) also provide misleading information due to the entry not being a first hand account but a summary of accounts from various different sources. However, even so, this helps to flesh out the details and provides additional information and clues as to what happened that were never recounted during the original press report .

There Mr. Drummond, who has known Mr. Taylor for more than the 16 years he has worked for the LDC, saw a distinct pattern of marks on the ground.

"In the centre were something like caterpillar tracks surrounded by deep triangular marks the size of a horse's hoof". said Mr. Drummond.

But there were not tracks going to and from the site which is surrounded by trees.

"What made them must have weighed more than a ton, possibly two tons."

"I can't explain what made those marks but it must have come straight down and gone straight back up again".

Mr. Drummond had no explanation for what caused Mr. Taylor's condition on Friday morning.

But he is in no doubt that Mr. Taylor is genuinely reporting what he saw or believes he saw.

"He is a very straightforward and serious bloke. He's not the type of man to make up fanciful stories".

Mr. Taylor's doctor persuaded him to go to Bangour General Hospital for a general check up to see if he was concussed.

He said he had suffered no ill effects from his experience on

On November 9, 1979, approximately between 10:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. Taylor, who was at the time working for the Livingston Development Corporation, parked his pickup truck at the side of a road just off the M8 motorway with the intention of examining the progress

of some saplings in the forest. Being unable to access the forest by truck, Taylor and his dog made their way into the forest on foot along one of the forest paths that lead up the side of Dechmont Law.

Upon entering a clearing approximately 500 meters away from his truck, Taylor saw what he described as a large, circular object, spheroid in shape and approximately twenty feet (six meters) in diameter hovering above the forest floor. The object had a narrow rim running along its circumference with stems topped with propellers and the surface of the object seemed to be constructed from a dark metallic material which appeared transparent in places. Taylor later described the surface of the object having rough texture similar to that of sandpaper and suggested that by having transparent areas on its surface, the object was attempting to camouflage itself with its surroundings.

Taylor began to approach the object and upon doing so two

smaller spheres three feet in diameter, which looked to be made from the same material, appeared to drop from underneath the larger sphere and began to roll towards him. Taylor described the smaller spheres as having appendages, making them similar to sea mines in appearance. As the small objects moved towards him, Taylor described them as making a "plopping" noise as the appendages made contact with the ground. The small spheres maneuvered around Taylor and by using their appendages, attached themselves to each side of his trousers, just underneath the pockets. Taylor said at this point, he heard a hissing noise coming from the small objects and he began to choke due to a strong acrid smell which he believes was being secreted by them. He described this smell as "burning automobile brake linings" which was also described as an "acrid smell" which caused him to cough. By now, Taylor was aware he was being dragged by the smaller spheres along the ground towards the larger object. He eventually fell forwards onto his face and lost consciousness.

Taylor later regained consciousness and upon doing so discovered the object had disappeared. Taylor then discovered he had trouble attempting to speak and could not get to his feet. He then crawled 100 meters along the ground and managed to stagger the rest of the

distance back to where he had parked his

truck. On reaching the truck he attempted to call for help on the truck's two way radio, but struggled due to his loss of voice. Taylor then attempted to get back home in the truck, but accidentally ditched it in soft earth while trying to drive in his condition. Due to his vehicle being stuck, Taylor walked the rest of the way back home. Other sources state the truck did not start and Taylor had to walk home from its parked location.

Taylor was always cited as being a man of good character, honest and reliable. He never asked for payment on reciting his version of events and up until his death at the age of 89 in 2007, still defended what he had seen on Dechmont Law. Today, a plaque (which was later stolen) and a small statuette are located in the clearing where Taylor stated he saw the object.

#### Investigation and evidence

Upon reaching home at 11:30 a.m., Mary Taylor, Taylor's wife, expressed concern at his state. She assumed he had been attacked and called the police. Taylor intervened and requested she contact Malcolm Drummond, a supervisor at Livingston Development Corporation. While awaiting Drummond's arrival, Taylor complained of a headache and kept saying that he had been "gassed". Drummond and Taylor

both attended the scene of the incident a short while later the same day and discovered strange indentations in the forest floor which Taylor stated had not been there earlier that morning. One set were described as looking like rungs in ladder, the other indentations which numbered forty in total were suspected to be the tracks left by the smaller objects. No scorch marks were seen on the forest floor. Staff of the Livingston Development Corporation later took photographs of the scene.

Mr. Taylor was seen by his doctor, Gordon Adams, who found only grazing to his chin and thighs. Due to his injuries the police recorded the matter as a common assault. Taylor's wife noticed tears in his trousers where Taylor claimed the small objects had attached themselves to him. The police led by Detective Sergeant Ian Wark later seized the trousers to be forensically examined. The forensic examination determined the tears in the trousers suggested the implements that had pierced the material, attempted to lift Taylor in an upwards fashion.

The trousers were later returned by the police and to this day are held by UFO researcher Malcolm Robinson.

#### Part 2 - Common theories and explanations

Over the years various theories have been put forward to try and explain the unusual events that happened that day.

The most obvious explanation is that the entire episode was a hoax. However, this has been ruled out by all of the investigators who have interviewed Mr. Taylor over the years. There seems to be common agreement that Robert Taylor was a man of integrity who honestly believed what happened that day was as he originally described. His story has always remained consistent even when faced with obvious doubters who may have questioned his honesty or even his sanity. One can only imagine how distressing it must have been for Mr. Taylor to have lived with this experience knowing in his heart of hearts that the story he relayed was just as he claimed – yet being aware that there were those that doubted his integrity. So given that we believe his story what other explanations are there?

Next we must consider that the events as





told were exactly what happened. The initial explanation was that this was an unidentified flying object that had landed in the woods and sent out robot sentinels to try and capture Mr. Taylor (for whatever purpose we can only imagine). Was the craft of extra-terrestrial origin or was there an alternative explanation? Some have claimed that the strange object was a secret military aircraft but this seems a highly unlikely explanation even though we now know that the military have always had classified aircraft (the stealth fighter being an obvious example). What would a secret military aircraft be doing hovering in a woodland clearing near a small town in central Scotland. There are no airbases nearby to spy upon, and there were no other witnesses to the event apart from Robert Taylor and his dog Lara.

If it had been a flying object (either terrestrial or extra terrestrial) why was it not seen either landing or taking off from the area which is on the boundary of Livingston (a small Town in central Scotland) and only ten or so miles from the outskirts of the city of Edinburgh. The area is quite heavily populated so surely someone would have seen it and reported it?

According to Malcolm Robinson, in his book "UFO Case Files of Scotland" there were a number of UFO reports around about that time. He cites references to examples uncovered by Ken Higgins (another UFO researcher) including a case of a factory worker on his way to work witnessing an orange light that suddenly disappeared at 8 pm. Another gentleman who was driving along the A8 near Dechmont reported seeing an orange ball like object that caused him to swerve his car, this happened between 7.30 and 8.00 am. And a lady on her way to work at nearby Bangour hospital reported hearing a hissing noise and a bright light in the sky at around 8.00am that morning.

Another theory was proposed by Steuart Campbell who initially proposed that Robert Taylor had observed an unusual example of "Black Ball Lightning" (a natural phenomena). This would be a variation of conventional ball lightning that for some (as yet unexplained) reason is dark grey in colour. However, while this would explain the "sightings" short duration and provides a possible explanation for the mysterious mine shaped Spheres and perhaps some of the effects this had on Mr. Taylors experi-



ence, the suggestion is easily disproved due to the lack of evidence of any burning which would be expected from a plasma field which is essentially "ball lightning". Secondly, the mysterious objects that attacked Mr. Taylor must have been physical objects capable of tearing cloth and physically pulling Mr. Taylor towards their craft.

A few years later, Steuart Campbell then went onto propose another theory in which he suggested that the planet Venus was responsible for the strange vision of the craft. His theory suggested that unusual weather patterns caused an inversion of atmospheric temperatures that could have resulted in a "mirage" of the planet Venus being seen in the clearing that day. He proposes that when a layer of warm air build up above a layer of cold air this could act like some sort of lens that would bend the path of light and effectively magnify the image of Venus so that it appeared to be hovering in the clearing. Other researchers examination of this theory, maintain that the planet Venus would have been below the horizon on the day and time the event occurred. However, Steuart Campbell has since countered that claim by explaining that the lens effect would also have bent the path of the light as it passed through the Earths atmosphere allowing it to be visible even though it was below the horizon at the time.

However, another problem is that the encounter happened in broad daylight when stars and planets are not visible in the sky anyway.

Whilst this is an interesting theory it is entirely unproven and no one has ever been able to demonstrate that this effect can actually occur. In any case, it still would not explain the actions of the "mine like spheres" that were obviously physical objects able to interact with Mr. Taylor.

UFO investigator Malcolm Robinson proposed that the object may have come from another dimension. His basis for suggesting this was the fact that mention was made that the object seemed to be merging with the background ("as if to camouflage itself"). Malcolm's interpretation of this phenomenon was that the object was "dematerialising from our universe into another parallel universe. Alternatively, he suggests that the object may have been from the future. i.e. an Earth based time machine piloted by humans from our own future who had travelled back in time for what reason we can only imagine. (Personally if I had a time machine I can think of a great many more interesting places and times to visit then Dechmont Law on a cold Autumn morning in November 1979).

And what of the mysterious indentations left on the ground?

It has been suggested that these were caused by heavy construction equipment. However, CID Detective Sergeant Ian Wark who investigated the case at the time checked all the forestry equipment used in the area and concluded that none of it had tracks that matched and there were no construction vehicles in the vicinity.

Another interesting theory has been proposed by David Slater. He suggests that the episode was triggered by deadly Nightshade poisoning (Otherwise known as Belladonna). He believes that Deadly Nightshade berries are prevalent in the area and may have been consumed by Mr. Taylor during his walk through he woods. Deadly nightshade produces a dark black berry fruit that may appear to be harmless but when consumed can cause hallucinations and memory disturbances that may explain Robert Taylor's story.

Around the time of the incident a TV program called “Dr Who” had recently been broadcast that contained images of a “spacecraft” that some claim looks very much like the description Robert Taylor gave of the “craft” he encountered in the woods.

The mysterious spheres may have been the belladonna poisoning causing Mr. Taylor to hallucinate that his own dog “Lara” was the mysterious spherical objects. The fact that he encountered two of them is explained by the double vision that the Belladonna poisoning may have induced in Mr. Taylor.

David Slater also proposed a highly plausible explanation for the strange markings found on the ground at the scene of the incident which I will recount later in the book.

Summary:-

So far we have a number of alternative suggestions for the Dechmont Law incident.

- 1/ The entire episode was a hoax
- 2/ Robert Taylor stumbled across a UFO in the woods that subsequently sent out robot machines in an attempt to abduct him just as he described.
- 3/ The experience was caused by a form of ball lighting.
- 4/ The UFO was a time machine from the future.
- 5/ The entire episode was a hallucination brought on by belladonna poisoning

Explanation 1/ is unsatisfactory due to Mr. Taylor's reputation as a man of sound character and integrity

Explanations 2/ 3/ and 4/ are unsatisfactory due to being unproven and “far fetched”

Explanation 5/ seems unlikely as this was a “one off” occurrence – why aren't there more examples of belladonna poisoning happening to others in the area?

What is needed is an explanation that **fits all the facts** but is “down to earth” (excuse the pun) and plausible.

And I believe I have just such an explanation.....

### Part 3 – Unusual structures

Situated between the M8 Motorway and Dechmont village to the North of Livingston, is a hilly section of forest that contains a couple of underground structures. Lying in a clearing in the forest alongside the M8 motorway (but hidden from view by trees) is a rectangular mound measuring about 300ft x 100ft. This structure is described as an underground reservoir on local maps (similar to others that are in the area).

Alongside this reservoir is another structure (an underground water tower) which consists of a large 100ft diameter dome sitting on top of a cylindrical base. Overall the entire building is rough-



- 1/ The Building is dome Shaped.
- 2/ The finish is a rough dark grey with a “sandpaper like” texture.
- 3/ It has a flange running around the edge.
- 4/ There are parts sticking up from the flange (safety railings) that from a distance could have been mistaken for propellers.

- 6/ There are access points on opposite sides and on


Below (Top): Authors Diagram of Robert Taylor’s “UFO” description

ly 30ft in height but as it sits below the level of the surrounding trees it remains hidden from view.

The dome itself is a roughly textured dark mat grey colour and the cylindrical structure supporting the dome is painted green (as if to blend in with the surroundings). At opposite ends of the dome shaped

structure are two access points complete with safety railings. A third opening is fitted directly on top of the dome.

The dome shaped structure matches the description of the “UFO” described by Robert Taylor almost word for word.

i.e.

top of the dome. (Later accounts of his experience given by Robert Taylor mention that there may have been “portholes” on the dome).

I am in no doubt that the “mysterious craft” Robert Taylor encountered in the woods on the morning of November 9<sup>th</sup> 1979 was this structure.

The real mystery is why did the police and other investigators who examined the scene at the time not realise this as well, and why has this never been mentioned before in the many articles written about this incident?

Part of the answer lies in the fact that the dome shaped structure is not in the location described and consequently was never investigated after the encounter. It is in fact about 200 or 300 yards away **on the opposite side of the motorway** and completely hidden from view from the location where the incident was alleged to have taken place.


We now have a convincing explanation for the “Craft” encountered by Robert Taylor. But what of the mysterious “Spheres” that attacked, gassed and tore his trousers that day? And why was the location where the incident took place incorrectly identified? The answers to these questions will be explained later on in this book.

I also want to go on and explain a bit more about the history of

Livingston New Town, it's strategic location in central Scotland, and the role this may have in explaining the Dechmont Law Incident, but before that a brief interlude:-

If the mysterious “craft” has now been explained, what was the cause of the strange markings found in (as we now know) the alternate location that Robert Taylor showed to the investigators.

I shall now describe to you exactly what did cause these strange markings before later going on to explain why I believe Robert Taylor led the investigators to this alternative location.... Originally it was thought that the small circular indentations measuring approximately 88mm in diameter would have been caused by the rolling action of the spiked mine shaped objects that attacked Robert Taylor. And the central caterpillar track like indentations would have been formed by the weight of the craft resting on some sort of undercarriage. However, there are a number of flaws in this explanation:-

David Slater (who proposed that Robert Taylor's encounter may have been a hallucination brought on by Deadly Nightshade poisoning) has a highly plausible explanation which I am inclined to agree with:-

Firstly, if we look closely at the spacing of the circular indentations it is obvious that they are irregularly spaced. If these marks were to have been made by the mine shaped objects described by Robert Taylor then we would have expected them to be regularly spaced. A sphere with fixed spikes will, when rolled, produce a pattern of indentations that do not vary in their spacing since the distance between the tip of each spike is a fixed distance apart

Therefore we are forced to accept that the mine shaped spheres were not responsible for the circular markings, and another cause must be established to explain these.

Secondly – at no time did Robert Taylor ever describe the mysterious craft as having any kind of undercarriage let alone “Caterpillar tracks”. In his original description of the incident he described the object as “hovering”. The police sketch plan of the markings simply bear no resemblance to the description of events as described by Robert Taylor which leaves us with no other alternative but to find another explanation for the marks.

One obvious explanation for the caterpillar tracks is that these must have been created by a tracked vehicle.. This was realised at the time of the Police investigation and the Detective handling the investigation checked out this theory by examining all of the tracked vehicles that were in use by the LDC Forestry department at the time. As a result of his investigation, he was able to rule this theory out since none of the vehicles in use matched the markings found. In any case, there was no sign of the “caterpillar” markings extending beyond the area that was affected. This would have had to have been the case if a vehicle had been driven

into and out of the area. A final possibility, that a tracked vehicle had been lowered into place by a crane was also ruled out. We are now left with no alternative but to find some other cause other than the encounter described by Robert Taylor for the unusual markings found in the clearing.

Was it just co-incidence that there happened to be markings that defied explanation in the area that an alleged encounter



shelter in the location of the alleged encounter in 1979 is still active today.

Therefore the explanation for the series of circular holes in the ground are:- that these were the posts making up a shelter that had occupied the space previously. The "caterpillar tracks" are the result of the seating or bedding arrangement that would have been constructed inside the shelter by placing a series of logs on the ground in the spacing's shown to create a raised dry seating or sleeping area

The next photograph shows such a seating arrangement in place inside the shelter.

To Summarise - We now have explanations for both the "Craft" that Robert Taylor encountered, and the mysterious ground markings that were discovered at the time. However, still unexplained is the reason why the location of the incident was incorrectly identified and answers to what were the mysterious "Mine shaped objects" that attacked gassed and damaged Mr. Taylor's clothing as well as causing his confusion and inability to walk and

talk properly? What is needed to satisfy the explanations offered up so far is a plausible set of answers to these unsolved questions. I would now like to suggest some possible solutions before finally revealing what I believe is the truth behind the Dechmont Law encounter.

David Slater suggests that these marking were as a result of a woodland shelter that had been constructed (and recently removed) in the area at the time of Mr. Taylors encounter.

Anyone who has investigated the area around Dechmont Law woods will be familiar with the type of woodland shelter seen in the next couple of photographs:-

These are constructed by arranging a series of posts made from logs, leaning them against each other to create a sort of Tepee. The posts are then covered with a sheet and branches or mud to produce a water and wind tight shelter as shown next.

The above and opposite two photos are of a structure I rediscovered myself when I investigated the area in August 2011. Clearly indicating that whatever, (or whoever) constructed a



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# The Broad Haven UFO Sighting

The Broad Haven UFO sighting is probably the most famous sighting in Wales, and has gained many names, including The Welsh Triangle. There has been a lot of publicity about this sighting, including media reports and books written on the incident. But what was so special about this, and why did this sighting attract so much attention?

On the 4th of February 1977, in a little village in West Wales, the Children of Broad Haven School witnessed something extraordinary during their school day. They saw a Cigar shaped craft in a field opposite their school. This craft didn't just disappear, the first sighting was at the 10 30 break time, and there were a few more sightings at lunchtime. And during one of their morning breaks, they saw a silver suited figure walking in the field.

Not all of the children saw the craft, the weather was a bit wet and drizzly, so some stayed inside. And when the children came in from play, they talked excitedly about what they had seen. But as you can imagine, the teacher and some of the other children didn't believe them, and thought they were making it up.

David Davies had not been out in the yard, and not seen any craft, but he had heard the other children talking about it, and was intrigued by this. So at the end of the day, David walked towards the back field, to where the other children had said they saw the craft. He was just about to climb over a boundary fence when he noticed a silver cigar shaped craft, which he said was about the same size as a bus, and it was coming up from behind the tree's. The craft was swaying slightly, and it seemed to stop; as if it was being stopped from going up, or hitting some sort of resistance. After a couple of attempts at doing this, it then went back down below tree level. Although David said he didn't feel afraid, he felt that he should run, and he turned and ran back to the school, where his taxi was waiting to take him and other school children back home. He said that there was no thought about running, it just happened.



When the children went to school the next day, they were still talking about the craft. And even though others had tried to tell them that they had not seen anything they were adamant that they had and refused to change their story. To test whether the children were telling the truth, the headmaster had them sitting in exam conditions, sitting separately on different desks, and in silence. And what happened next he wasn't expecting at all. The children drew more or less the same thing; there are slight differences in what they had drawn, which was to be expected, but they had each drawn a similar craft, and some of the children had included the being with who had been walking by the craft.

But it wasn't just the children who had seen a craft. About two weeks later, an object was seen by a teacher at the same primary school, but she only saw it briefly, because they had heavy rain that day. She was about to call others to witness this, but it

floated away with a humming sound. And later on that same day; two people who were working at the school noticed an object at the same location, and watched a figure climb out and move up the slope of the field.

It is because of these sighting, that Broad Haven became inundated with media presence. But as we know with cases of UFO sightings, there is a lot of publicity about the sighting, and nothing

to explain why the UFO was there. It is turned into a farce, they bring in so called witnesses to prove that it was not a UFO, that it was something else, something that could easily be explained. This happened with the children and people of Broad haven, these so called experts tried to say that it could have been a farm vehicle, or sewage truck. But the area the craft was seen was bog area and a vehicle couldn't drive there. And these children live in a farming area, which has a lot of farm & military vehicles driving though on a regular basis, so they knew all about these vehicles.

This is what happens with media coverage of sightings, it is all about trying to prove whether what they saw was real or not. There is no acknowledgement that it was a UFO, or no investigation into the things that we really want to know, like who

were these beings were, and most importantly, why were they revealing themselves to so many people at this time, what was going on in the area for this to happen. The people who read about the incidences only get to read about the sightings, and nothing else. And because there is a big emphasis on what the experts believe, it still makes people doubt whether it really happened, and most of the time they just brush it off.

But as we know, there is always a reason why things happen. We are not dull; I think we all know that aliens are real; every day in areas around the world, there are sightings of UFO's. And there is talk about them in all of the history books, including religious texts. But you cannot get the media to admit to this, or investigate any of it. But there are groups all over the world who want to know about these things, and they form their own groups and link with others, especially people who have been investigating these types of things. And it is because of them, we get to see a bigger picture; and quite often it is to do with military action. In some cases we have discovered that the things that they were doing were becoming a danger to people, and that was why the

and when this happens, the activity stops. I think this is really good early warning system. For me, when I think about sightings like this, they seem to be like a beacon, shouting out to us; "Hey, take a look at this area, there is something happening over here that you should know about." There are a number of cases where UFO's have been sighted, and after investigation we find out that there was military action in area, and quite often something to do with nuclear weapons. And it appears that the UFO sighting in Broad Haven revealed that there were many things happening in that area that people were not aware of.


Once an investigation began it was discovered that there were some very strange things going on in the area. It appeared that the events at Broad Haven were only a part of what has been happening. Along the St Brides Bay coastline, just up the hill at Haven Fort Hotel, Rosa Granville who owned the hotel said she had seen a saucer-shaped UFO outside of the hotel window. She saw a silver suited humanoid in a field on top of a hidden nuclear fallout shelter.

A bit further round the coastline, there is a farm called Ripperston Farm which has experienced a lot of strange events, more noticeably between January – December 1977. On the night of the 14th of January 1977, Pauline Coombs saw a great ball of

incandescent light hanging motionless over the field near the cliff top. It was not unusual to see strange lights in the sky, as RAF Brawdy was not far away and there were lots of flights in and out of the area. But the light Pauline saw looked different, after approximately twenty minutes the light started to move, swinging from side to side and slowly descending. And as it got

nearer to the ground it disappeared below the cliff. Pauline woke up her husband, who was sleeping in a chair at the time. He went to the cliff top path to search for whatever the object was, but unfortunately, Billy could find anything. Billy didn't really think Pauline had seen a UFO, but he did admit that there were some strange things going on. He was quoted as saying "There were as many as fifty frogmen below the cliff. Unmarked army trucks, soldiers in camouflage. The Navy was also there building some sort of path beneath the water. This doesn't make sense!"

After this, Pauline and her children saw a bright light in the sky while driving home, which 'chased' their car and even flew straight at them. The husband, Billy, saw it too that night when it was outside of their house, and soon their TVs started burning out and cars broke down. One Friday evening, as Pauline and Billy were



watching a movie on television, Pauline was distracted by a flickering light in the window, and the whining of their dog Blackie. The light was still there after an hour, and Billy (who had fallen asleep) was woken by what he thought was car headlights. He then noticed a "shimmering figure" of a man at the window. The figure was wearing a silver suit and apparently seven foot tall. It didn't move and just seemed to be staring inside. Billy commented that there was only blackness where the face should have been, and it sounded as if the man at the window was wearing a helmet with a shaded visor (much like astronauts would use). A little while later the figure at the window raised a gloved hand to the glass, which started to rattle. At the same time the lights dimmed and the television stopped working. Billy managed to call his neighbour and the police, and when the police siren could be heard approaching the farm, the figure vanished. While all this was going on the dog refused to go out and didn't want to go out which is very unusual. The following morning Pauline discovered a scorched rose bush in the flower bed and huge footprints beneath the window.

A newspaper reported a sighting involving a "Jelly Mould" shaped UFO in a garden near the farm, which was said to be fifteen feet high and fifty feet wide. Shortly after reading this in the newspaper, Pauline's friend, Rosa, telephoned to say that she had seen a dome shaped UFO in a field next to the hotel

where she lived. It produced a light and two tall, human like, figures got out and appeared to be searching for something on the ground. The description of the figures seemed to match the one seen at Pauline and Billy's window. Rosa said the figures returned to the craft after about twenty minutes and it flew off at great speed, in the direction of the farm.

This was a strange enough, but a sighting on the 12th of November was perhaps the most bizarre of all. After seeing a UFO in the daytime, which performed some spectacular manoeuvres, it suddenly plunged into the sea by the famous Stack Rocks. Pauline took her kids with her to investigate this further from the cliff tops, and on the rocks below she saw two figures in silver suits, who she estimated to be between eight to twelve feet tall. She noticed a door in the rocks, where one of the figures emerged and they moved around the base of the rock. After the figures returned through the door, it faded away and could no longer be seen. On returning home, Pauline received a call from her friend Rosa. Apparently, she had been looking at Stack Rocks with her binoculars and saw a silvery UFO fly into an entrance on the Rock. Sometime later silver-suited figures came out of the opening in the Rock and climbed down to the sea and back again several times.

Why was all of this happening, what was so special about this area?

It is from researchers like Peter Paget and Neil Spring that we have found out that there was a lot of military activity happening in the area. RAF Brawdy and The American Oceanographic Research Station (which was actually a military / Nato Underwater Submarine surveillance Station) was near this, and there were American troops at the base. And there are testimonies that there were underground bases and an underwater path that lead to Stack Rock, which there had been many strange sightings. There was also a missile testing station not far from there. A Soviet submarine had also been spotted in St Bride's bay, and all

does make you ask the question; when people were reporting these sightings, why wasn't there an investigation into this.

People in the local area knew that something was happening, outsiders would come and some would stay at the hotel. Neil Spring spoke to Rosa's daughter Francine & she told him about 4 Americans who were working at the base, who were staying at the hotel. She would cook their meals, and if they were going to be late home, they would ring her to let her know. One night they rung her and told her that they were going to be really late, and when they got back, they seemed agitated, and the lady that was with them was distraught and they were having a lot of difficulty trying to pacify her. The two men seemed really anxious to get the woman off to bed, they didn't want her talking. As they went up the stairs, she turned around and said "You don't know how close we came tonight", or words to that effect, which implies that something was going on at the base. And we know that they were monitoring nuclear

submarines

All of this was happening, and even though many people in the area had many strange sightings, and were reporting them, nobody was taking any notice. None of the outside world knew anything about this; that was until a group of children saw a UFO in the field by their school, and they were adamant what they saw was real.

Is this where the connection lies? It makes you ask that question; is this the reason that they show themselves, to make us aware of what is happening, and to put a stop to this type of thing? There have been reports of other sightings, where UFO's have been seen deactivating nuclear weapons. Is that what they are doing, this their way of showing us that they are helping us. It was because of this sighting that people came to the area, and I can't help but think that this was the reason that many of the activities around the area stopped. The Americans went home, and the underground bases were filled in. And after hearing what the woman said, that you don't know how close we came, this proved that something needed to be done, so in my eyes, they were helping us.

It also makes you ask that question, who is watching who?

I am sure that there are many other things that they are doing to help us, not just this type of this. I am sure that this is just one side to it. Myself I have seen some very strange sightings which show them helping in other ways. They have other teams who are working on helping to create things that can help us, helping to create events where people come together. They can walk amongst us then, helping to lift the energies, without anyone really knowing that they are there. But if you look close enough, you will see them, and they will smile, and you will know that that they are all around us

As you can see there's a lot more to the St Brides Bay than just The Broad Haven Incident.
