TOPSEC PLUS

We have long believed that when a superpower needs to conceal information from the rest of the world and even from its own citizens, it can do so with almost total success. It may not, however, always feel the necessity for the ruthless measures complete concealment demands, for if leaked information can be discredited the aim is still achieved. One way to destroy the credibility of the whistleblower is to remove all proof that he ever had access to classified information and suggest that he is in fact some sort of crazed publicity seeker. Another is to cast doubt on the veracity of the information itself by releasing contrary but apparently well-authenticated facts which undermine it.

Either or both of these factors may have been involved in responses to claims made by Robert Lazar about the testing of alien craft at the Groom Lake installations. His disclosures have been investigated by both Timothy Good and Jacques Vallée, but to put forward his own case Lazar has released a cassette, most of which we have transcribed to offer readers Lazar's first hand account as he wished it presented. Concerning its validity, they will of course make their own judgements. A similar consideration applies to the statements by Milton Cooper, who believes also that maximum publicity is his best insurance, for if whistleblowers disappear in suspicious circumstances the credibility of their revelations is obviously enhanced. The article by the anonymous American scientist, who apparently does not share this belief, seems to suggest that because some reported abductions may in fact conceal the mind control established over certain US intelligence agents, this can therefore explain all abduction cases. It can hardly be so.

We have no evidence either to support or to disprove the assertions of these three men, but we believe each has a right to be heard. When there's so much smoke, there must be a fire somewhere!



THE USE OF ALIEN TECHNOLOGY BY THE U.S. GOVERNMENT

The vehicle that uses the alien technology is a disk. The reactor provides an enormous amount of power. This power source uses Element 115 as a fuel and uses a total annihilation reaction to provide the heat which it converts to energy, making it a compact, lightweight, efficient on board power source.

I had only partial views of nine different disks, but the one I'm going to describe to you now is the one in which I not only saw two of the three interior levels, but I also saw it fully functional in flight. And no! Unfortunately I didn't get to go for a ride in it.

This particular disk appeared to be in excellent condition, and because of its sleek appearance I nicknamed it "the sport model." The sport model is about 16 feet tall and 40 feet in diameter. The exterior skin of the disk is metal, which is the colour of unpolished stainless steel. The sport model sits on its belly when it's not energised. The hatch is located on the upper half of the disk, with just the bottom portion of the door wrapping around the centre lip of the disk. The interior level of the disk is divided into 3 levels. The lower level is where the 3 gravity amplifiers and amplifier guides are located. These are the things used to amplify and focus the gravity wave.

The reactor is located directly above the three gravity amplifiers on the centre level and is in fact centred between them. The centre level of the disk also houses the control consoles and seats, both of which were too small and too low to the floor to be functional for adult human beings. The walls at the centre level are all divided into archways. At one point in time when the disk was energised one of the archways became transparent and you could see the area outside of it just as if the archway was a window. After the panel had been transparent for a while, a form of writing which was unlike any alphabetic, scientific or mathematical symbols I have ever seen began to appear on the transparent archway, and I was never informed as to how all this was achieved. Not that any of that would have required alien technology. I was never given access to the upper level of the disk, so I can't enlighten you as to what the porthole-like areas are, other than I can assure you that they're not portholes.

My job in this programme was to be part of a back-engineering team. Back-engineering is the act of taking a finished product and tearing it apart to find out what makes it tick. The goal in this programme was to see if the technology of the disk could be duplicated with earth material. When I went to work I was flown from an airport in Las Vegas to Area 51, which is a highly secure government base on the Nevada test site. Area 51 is located about 125 miles north of Las Vegas, near the Groom Mountains and the Groom Dry Lake bed. From Area 51 I was bussed to an even more highly secure facility located about 15 miles south of Area 51, called S4. S4 is located at the base of the Papoose Mountains, by the Papoose Dry Lake bed. The airspace around S4 is restricted and if any unwelcome aircraft strays into the outer sector, they radio the pilot and instruct him or her to leave. If that pilot continues and strays into the middle sector, jets will be scrambled to escort the intruding aircraft out. If for any reason whatsoever that aircraft penetrates into the inside

sector before jets can be airborne, ground-air missiles will neutralise the intruder. The moral of this story is (Now hear this, Busty!): "Don't try and fly into S4!"

The S4 installation is built into the mountain and the 9 hangar doors are angled at about 60 degrees. These doors are covered with a sand textured coating to blend in with the side of the mountain and the desert floor. The hangar that housed the sport model was like a typical airplane hangar, with the exception of the angled doors. The hangar was equipped with typical tools and extensive electronic equipment. It also had a machine with an X-ray emblem on it and an overhead crane rated at 20,000 pounds. Equipment in this hangar was marked with a black number 41 with a white circle round it. It was outside of this hangar that I saw the sport model tested.

The programme outer area at S4 consisted of 3 projects; Project Galileo, Project Sidekick and Project Looking Glass. Project Galileo dealt with gravity propulsion, Project Sidekick dealt with a beam weapon and Project Looking Glass dealt with the physics of seeing back in Time. Now I was not personally involved with the hardware of Projects Sidekick or Looking Glass and those projects are beyond my scope.

There's a small segment of the U.S. government that makes scientific and technical judgements from a knowledge base that is not available to the general public. If the following information is true, the U.S. government also makes judgements on a historical, philosophical and even theological level, from a knowledge base that is not available to the general public. These are excerpts from some of that information.

As part of my indoctrination into the programme at S4, I would randomly be taken into a small room which contained a table, a chair and 120 or so briefings in blue folders. I'd be left there to read for varying amounts of time, usually about half an hour. These briefings contained a wide spectrum of information, mostly relating to aliens and alien technology. These reports appeared to be an overview of alien information which could be used to brief scientists from any field about the scope of the whole project, and not just their specific field of endeavour. The overview of Project Galileo was accurate. I read the overview and later witnessed evidence which proved it to be accurate, so it is possible that scientists involved with other projects could have seen evidence that these other overviews were also accurate, but I can't make that assertion. To me these reports were just words on paper, so to keep from saying "allegedly" or "supposedly" in every sentence I relay this information to you just as I read it.

This technology was brought here by some alien beings from the Zeta Reticuli 1 and 2 star systems. These stars are located in the constellation Reticulum, which can only be seen from the southern hemisphere. Zeta Reticuli is a binary star system and is located approximately 30 light years from Earth. These beings are from Reticulum 4, which is the 4th planet out from Zeta Reticuli 2. A day on Reticulum 4 is 90 Earth hours long. The beings are 3 to 4 feet tall and weight 25 to 50 pounds. They have greyish skin and large heads with almond shaped wrap-around eyes. They have very slight nose, mouth and ear positions and are hairless.

Any dates in the information regarding these beings was written in a 6-digit number which began with 1623. Since I had no idea what the 6-digit number was for the present year, I had no way of calculating when these beings arrived, or at least arrived this time. These beings said they had been visiting Earth for a

long time and presented photographic evidence which they contended was over 10,000 years old. There was an exchange of hardware and information in central Nevada until 1979, at which time there was a conflict which brought the programme to an abrupt halt.

The beings left, but were to return at a 1623 date, and I don't know what that date is. With the remaining hardware and information the U.S. government started the back-engineering programme. In May of 1987 some scientists took an anti-matter reactor to an underground blast facility on the Nevada test site to perform an experiment. Unfortunately for them, their experiment required them to cut the reactor open, which resulted in their deaths. This explosion was explained to others at the test site as a previously unannounced low yield underground nuke test. I was hired in December of 1988 to replace one of these men.

The beings conveyed information about the capability of affecting the human brain to anaesthetise the human body. This is done without any physical contact, from a remote source. For this anaesthesia to be accomplished the brain has to be in a relaxed state similar to that required for hypnosis. If the brain is subject to any external stimulation, like stimulant drugs or loud music, this manipulation of the nervous system is ineffective.

These beings said that Man was the product of externally corrected evolution. They said that Man as a species has been genetically altered 65 times. They refer to humans as "containers", yet I don't know what we're containers of. It was impossible for me to corroborate the information in this section, and obviously if this information is true the ramifications are far-reaching and you don't have to be a nuclear physicist to figure that out!




CLOSE ENCOUNTER?

At approximately 10 pm on Friday 16 July 1993, Mr. Colin ██████████-██████████ of Reading (aged 37 - Tel:0734-██████████) and his wife Maria were driving along the tree-lined B3024 road at a point about half way between Whistley Green and Waltham St. Lawrence, Berks., in the Reading/Maidenhead area.

They stopped their car to observe through the trees a cigar shaped object hovering motionless above a field. It seemed to be a featureless patch of white or yellowish light, as though bathed in mist. They observed it for some 20 minutes, during which it made a slow movement to the West, then turned about to reveal a circular cross-section, and finally returned Eastwards. There was a "pin-point" of red light moving about near the object, whose length was estimated at 150 feet, its breadth between 50 and 75 feet, and its height above ground about 500 feet, seen at an angle of 20 degrees to the ground.

Mr. ██████████-██████████ felt a strong desire to approach the object, but his wife found it disturbing and wanted to get away from it. They felt it could not be any normal kind of aerial object, and neither had previously encountered any kind of UFO. Mr. ██████████-██████████ impressed the investigator as a responsible and articulate witness, who had taken the initiative in reporting the sighting, which is classified as MA1 in Vallée's taxonomy, and later proved to be an IFO!

EXTRACTS FROM THE MILTON COOPER FILE

I, Milton William Cooper, 1311 S.Highland ~205, Fullerton, California, 92632, (714) 680-9357, do solemnly swear that the information contained in this file is true and correct to the best of my knowledge. I swear that I saw this information in 1972 in the performance of my duties as a member of the Intelligence Briefing Team of the Commander in Chief of the Pacific Fleet as a Petty Officer in the US Navy. Please make copies of this file and send it to your Congressman, your Senator, the Attorney General of the United States and to the Supreme Court. Send it also to everyone you know. This file contains the absolute true information regarding the alien presence on earth and the US Government's involvement with the aliens.

The following is a brief listing of everything that I personally saw and know from 1972 and does not contain any input from any other source whatsoever.

MAJESTY was listed as the code word for the President of the United States for communications concerning this information.

OPERATION MAJORITY is the name of the operation responsible for every aspect, project and consequence of alien presence on earth.

GRUDGE contains 16 volumes of documented information collected from the beginning of the United States investigation of Unidentified Flying Objects (UFOs) and Identified Alien Crafts (IAC). The project was funded by CIA confidential funds (non- appropriated) and money from the illicit drug trade. Participation in the illegal drug trade was justified in that it would identify and eliminate the weak elements of our society.

MJ12 is the name of the secret control group. President Eisenhower commissioned a secret society known as THE JASON SOCIETY (Jason Scholars) to sift through all the facts ... and find the truth of the alien question. The society was made up of 32 of the most prominent men in the country in 1972 and the top 12 members were designated MJ12. MJ12 has total control over everything. They are designated by the codes J1, J2 etc., all the way through members of the Jason Society. The Director of the CIA was appointed J1 and is the Director of MJ12. MJ12 is responsible only to the President. MJ12 runs most of the world's illegal drug trade. This was done to hide funding and thus keep the secret from the Congress and people of the United States. The cost of funding the alien connected projects is higher than anything you can imagine. MJ12 assassinated President Kennedy when he informed them that he was going to tell the public all the facts of the alien presence. He was killed by the Secret Service agent driving his car and it is plainly visible in the film held from public view. A secret meeting place was constructed for MJ12 in Maryland and it was described as only accessible by air. It contains full living, recreational and other facilities for MJ12 and the Jason Society. It is code named THE COUNTRY CLUB and only those with TOP SECRET/MAJIC clearance are allowed to go there.

MAJI is the Majority Agency for Joint Intelligence. All information, disinformation and intelligence is gathered and evaluated by this agency. All alien projects are under its control and it is responsible only to MJ12.

SIGMA is the project which first established communication with the aliens and is still responsible for communications, and PLATO is the project responsible for diplomatic relations with the aliens. The terms were that the aliens would give us technology. In return we agreed to keep their presence on earth secret, not to interfere in any way with their actions and to allow them to abduct humans and animals. The aliens agreed to furnish MJ12 with a list of abductees on a periodic basis. AQUARIUS is a project which compiled the history of alien presence and their interaction with Homo Sapiens upon this planet for the last 25,000 years.

POUNCE is the project formed to recover all downed/crashed craft and aliens, while REDLIGHT is the project to test fly recovered alien craft. It is conducted at Area 51 (Dreamland) in Nevada. SNOWBIRD was established as a cover for REDLIGHT. Several saucer type craft were built using conventional technology and flown in front of the press. The purpose was to explain accidental sightings or disclosure of REDLIGHT as having been SNOWBIRD craft.

LUNA is the alien base on the far side of the moon. It was seen and filmed by the Apollo astronauts. A base, a mining operation using very large machines, and the very large alien craft described in sighting reports as MOTHER SHIPS exist there. ALIEN BASES exist in the four corners area of Utah, Colorado, New Mexico and Nevada. Six bases were described in the 1972 papers, all on Indian reservations and all in the four corners area.

JOSHUA is a project to develop a low frequency pulsed sound generating weapon. It was said that this weapon would be effective against the alien craft and beam weapons. EXCALIBUR is a weapon to destroy the alien underground bases. It is to be a missile capable of penetrating 1000 meters of tough hard packed soil such as that found in New Mexico. The device will carry a 1 Megaton nuclear warhead.

There were four types of ALIENS mentioned in the papers. A large nosed Grey, with whom we have the treaty; the Grey reported in abductee cases that works for the large nosed Grey, a blond human like type described as NORDIC and a red haired human like type called the ORANGE. The homes of the aliens are said to be stars in the constellations of Orion, Barnard's Star and Zeta Reticuli 1 and 2. EBE is the name or designation given to the live alien captured at the 1949 Roswell crash. He died in captivity.

The aliens claim to have created Homo Sapiens through hybridization. The papers said that RH blood was proof of this. They further claimed to have created all four major religions. ABDUCTIONS were occurring long before 1972. The document stated that humans and animals were being abducted and or mutilated. Many vanished without a trace. They were taking sperm and ova samples, tissue, performed surgical operations, implanted a spherical device 40 to 80 microns in size near the optic nerve in the brain, and all attempts to remove it resulted in the death of the patient. The document estimated that 1 in every 40 people had been implanted. This implant was said to give the aliens total control over that human.

A CONTINGENCY PLAN, should the information become public or should the Aliens attempt a takeover, called for a public announcement that a terrorist group had entered the United States with an atomic weapon. It would be announced that the terrorists planned to detonate the weapon in a major city. Martial Law would be declared and all persons with implants would be rounded up along with all dissidents and would be placed in concentration camps. The press, radio and TV would be nationalized and controlled. Anyone attempting to resist would be arrested or killed. The documents stated that many military and government personnel had been terminated (murdered without the process of law) when they attempted to reveal the secret.

The plan called for the use of MAJESTIC TWELVE as a disinformation ploy to delay and confuse the release of information should anyone get close to the truth. It was selected because of the similarity of spelling and the similarity to MJ12. It was designed to confuse memory and to result in a fruitless search for material which did not exist.

UFOs in the BIBLE

There are many references to aircraft in the bible, but they are not always clear because of the way they have been translated by scholars who wrote at a time when mankind had no aircraft and no memory of them. The Hebrew word used for aircraft (meaning "ship" or "ark") can also mean "cloud", which seemed more appropriate to these translators, so they wrote that "*a pillar of cloud*" led the Israelites out of Egypt, and there are many stories of "clouds" descending, people getting out for a talk and then returning to the "cloud", which rises up and flies away at high speed. In Exodus 6.10, "*the glory of the Lord appeared in the cloud*", and the crew of this machine lent the Israelites a food producing machine. Forty years later they took it back. (Joshua 5, 12-15)

Mount Sinai was frequently used for spacecraft landings, like the one in Exodus 19.18:

"And Mount Sinai was altogether on smoke, because the Lord descended on it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly."

On this occasion the astronauts gave Moses the instructions for building the Ark of the Covenant, which could produce electrical discharges and lethal radiation. The Ark seems to have been the power source for the manna machine described in the Kabbalah, which also contains details of a two-way radio system, which is why prayers to the gods had to be said aloud if they were to be heard.

Sometimes "the Lord" himself came down in a cloudy pillar, "*and the Lord spake unto Moses face to face, as a man speaketh unto his friend ...*" (Exodus 33.9-11, Numbers 11.25 and 12.5.) Such personal contacts ceased after the Israelites reached the land of Canaan, but radio contact apparently continued, perhaps through the seven pronged candlestick near the Ark, as in 1.Samuel 3.10. Many years later, when the Ark was placed in Solomon's temple, there were ten of these seven pronged devices and also a huge parabolic dish called "the sea".

The best known biblical aircraft is probably Ezekiel's fiery chariot and the one which took up the prophet Elijah. The one described by Ezekiel seems to have been a quadruple rotor helicopter, probably acting as a shuttle to a larger craft. When Ezekiel was a prisoner of war in Chaldea, Daniel was living in King Nebuchadnezzar's palace in Babylon, where he too received visits from astronauts. One of them apologised for arriving late, having heard Daniel's prayer on the temple radio, because he had been held up for a fortnight by a prince in Persia. The priest Zecharia (5.1 & 2) was often accompanied by an "angel" and once saw a UFO:

"Then I turned and lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and beheld a flying roll. And he said unto me, What seest thou? And I answered, I see a flying roll: the length thereof is twenty cubits, and the breadth thereof is ten cubits."

The UFO was therefore at least 29 feet long and 14 feet across, perhaps rather small for a passenger carrying "cloud", but we don't know how reliable Zecharia's estimate was. Such "clouds" were not, of course, confined to the Old Testament, and

it will be recalled that, forty days after the crucifixion, Jesus said farewell to his disciples, "and when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight." (Acts 1.9)

Bible reading can easily prove misleading without the background of study necessary to be sure one has the correct interpretation, and really requires some knowledge of the original languages employed. Jesus, for instance, almost certainly spoke Aramaic, but the first writing of the gospels would have been in demotic Greek, just as the language of the Old Testament is Hebrew. The writer David Medina, in his book *ELOHIM'S NURSERY*, (Regency Press) has set out all the biblical UFO encounters and other similar material. The BBS is open 24 hours a day and is accessed on 0691-671900, usual BBS protocols, except that the invitation to press <ESCAPE> twice should be ignored by everyone who does not understand what it does. This includes me, for I found that accepting it locked up my keyboard! Operating speeds are from 300 to 9600 baud, and the address for snail mail is The Observatory, Top Street, Whittington, Shropshire. SY11 4DR. It's sad that so many BUFORA workers, all convinced that an Amstrad WP with 3 inch disks is still state of the art, won't be able to log on.

It may be of both astronomical and ufological interest that, in a recent conversation, Z.Sitchin told me that a space probe from NASA is currently on its way to Mars and that, contrary to previous practice, no part of its findings will be released until five months after its mission is complete. Presumably this will give the MIBs plenty of time for censorship of any further data about the Martian pyramids, the subterranean heat-emitting areas and the huge human face previously recorded by Soviet missions!

GENDER-SPECIFIC PERCEPTION OF THE SIGNIFICANCE OF UFO SIGHTINGS

Early UFO investigators loaded their reports with astronomical and meteorological data on the assumption that if you are uncertain of what is significant then you record everything you can, in the hope that some of it will turn out to be useful. Nowadays, however, instead of concentrating on random but allegedly objective data in the belief that such facts are somehow more scientific, investigators are beginning to study also the effect of the encounter on the witnesses themselves. It is of course essential in case study that we always compare like with like, and fortunately I have recently been able to investigate three cases which are absolutely parallel in a number of important respects.

All three were reported by couples of opposite sex, with a separate account from each partner. Each is a unique event, by which I mean that neither before nor since has any participant claimed another UFO encounter, and finally each of the three cases involves the projection of the "cone of silence", when it is thought that witnesses somehow enter for a time the UFO reality, causing the temporary exclusion from consciousness of normal mundane events.

The most interesting common features of these three UFO encounters lie in the essentially similar attitudes to the UFO sighting experience adopted by witnesses of the same sex, and the marked difference in the reactions of all three men from those of their respective female companions. These could be briefly characterised by saying that the typically male attitude to a UFO encounter is one of excitement, modified by a detached yet fascinated curiosity about the objective details of the UFO's behaviour, of which they have good recall, and a total disregard or possibly unawareness of any personal danger. The typical female reaction, however, seems to be both subjective and emotional, coupled with a direct apprehension of a personal threat. Though these differential reactions may to some extent contain elements of socially constructed role perceptions, they cannot really be attributed mainly to some postulated masculine need for self-presentation in a macho mode and a corresponding feminine willingness to confess without shame to feeling afraid. Neither sex has a monopoly of courage and it seems from the witness accounts much more likely that women's experience and perception of the UFO encounter is simply different in kind from that of men, and that they become aware of elements in the pervasive UFO reality field by which men either remain unaffected or which they simply do not perceive.

The three encounters I wish to consider in this regard are the Pitch Hill UFO of 5 November 1988, reported by Karen and Philip; the Westcott UFO of 17 April 1982 seen by Christine and Peter, and the Twyford UFO of 16 July 1993 described by Colin and Maria. In each case we shall be considering only details relevant to the gender differential, our immediate concern. Interestingly, all three couples made their initial observations from cars.

In the case of the youngest pair, Karen's car was parked and Philip was in the passenger seat when the UFO was first seen. I asked why he got out of the car and Karen did not.

"Just to see it better," he answered. "I was very excited by it, the whole thing was ... we both felt it was a strange atmosphere. When I got out of the car everything was quiet - there wasn't a sound! No animals, no wind, nothing at all, as there would have been normally ... I suppose I was very excited to start with, but then when it went and the wind came back, I did feel a little bit insecure ..."

A curious adjective in the context, perhaps, and the least macho of the male reactions, doubtless influenced by Karen's anxiety and her repeated requests to get back in the car so they could move away.

Peter's original account is totally factual and says nothing of his feelings when he "drove up the kerb with surprise" at the sight of the UFO close at hand, and turned back hoping to see it again. Interviewed by me ten years after the event, he spoke of his extreme excitement, "with the adrenalin pumping", as concern to turn the car occupied his whole attention, ignoring his partner's frantic requests to drive on. He had no doubt that what he had seen was a UFO and said so at the time.

When Colin, journeying with Maria along the A4 towards Reading, saw from his parked car "an illuminated object of cylindrical shape, resembling a short, fat cigar ... possibly 500 feet above the ground and about 2 miles away", he rapidly concluded that he "was seeing an extra-terrestrial spacecraft", and described its movements in minute detail. When, at his wife's insistence, they broke off the encounter, he had "wanted very much to stay and actually attempt to get ... as close as possible to the object. I was feeling a sense of self-imposed loss, sorry to be leaving this thing behind," he wrote. Certainly none of the three men described themselves as being in any way afraid of the possible consequences of their UFO encounters, but the opposite is true of their partners, all of whom expressed varying degrees of fear and apprehension.

Though Karen was able to give a good account of the UFO's movements because in addition to feeling afraid she was also interested and curious about it, having always wanted to see a UFO, at the moment of truth she urgently wanted only to get away. I asked her why she did not get out of the car at the same time as her boy friend:

"There was a reason," she replied. "I was frightened because it was so very quiet and I had this odd feeling about the quietness. I didn't know what it was, and I was frightened ... I kept telling Phil to get back in the car, because I wanted to go!"

Christine's account gives an excellent example of the contrasting behaviours of each of the pair at the crucial moment of recognition, the time when it can no longer be dismissed as a joke:

"Peter wound the window down and said: 'Christ! It is a UFO!' Immediately my legs went to jelly - I felt absolutely petrified, my whole body just felt like a jelly. He was going berserk, right up on the kerb ... and I looked behind me and I said: 'Go home, just keep driving!' but he said, 'No, I'm going back, I'm going back!' and as we went past it I looked behind me

and there were two bloomin' great orange jet burners and that made me feel even more scared. It was so eerie, it was horrible, unbelievable. It was an evil looking shape."

Maria's responses were the most complex and severe in their effects upon her. "My immediate reaction," she wrote, "was, no, this couldn't be anything so ridiculous as a flying saucer ... I convinced myself that it had to be a helicopter ... Then *something made me decide* that it couldn't be a helicopter ... I really became quite alarmed. I am a Roman Catholic and in my state of anxiety I reached for my rosary beads in my handbag and focused my thoughts on God ... *I had a distinct feeling that perhaps the bright object knew that we had seen it* ... I was transfixed much of the time in a state of fear at this bright object ... This experience has affected me deeply. During the last few days I have felt very anxious and threatened ... Even writing this report was a frightening experience."

From the foregoing it is undeniably clear that what would superficially appear to be a single shared identical experience, common to two people, is in fact perceived totally differently by each, according to his or her gender. None of these women was anything other than a competent, intelligent adult, psychologically totally within the parameters we choose to call normal. Why then should their experience of the phenomenon be so different from that of men, and such as to reduce them to incomprehensible terror? Well, of course we don't know, but we can perhaps speculate that they may enter unwittingly into some possibly subconscious form of communication with UFO entities, becoming aware of intentions which, though not necessarily overtly formulated, are none the less felt to be threatening, especially by females.

When we look at the abduction literature, - the stolen eggs, the manipulated wombs - we can readily see how this could be so, and if apprehension of sexual violation and exploitation is communicated even subliminally, it would certainly provide every justification for the fears described. Men don't feel so defensive about spermatozoa or regard them as potential babies, and they have unlimited millions of them to spare. Perhaps the psychological consequences of this basic physical differentiation of the germ plasm are the unacknowledged cause of the gender-specific reactions we have been considering?

TAILPIECE

Subsequent investigation has shown the phenomenon reported by Colin and Maria to have been in fact an IFO - the Virgin airship, working with a helicopter on a film production.

Nevertheless, Maria's extreme reaction, triggered by the IFO, still suggests that she has experienced previous UFO contact, but her current state of mind indicates that hypnotic regression would be inadvisable at present, even if she wished it. Colin found that, in conversation with friends about his report before the IFO had been identified, none of them were inclined to scoff and some had themselves experienced similar encounters which, however, they had never reported to any ufologist.

Over the many years, I have watched from the auditorium the unfolding of an epic performance. Many no-names leapt on to the stage, passed the audition and became stars overnight. This real life soap opera was to last for more than a decade with a following larger than Brookside.

I am of course referring to the late lamented crop circles saga with an appeal and visual majesty that could not be denied, but origins that could be hotly debated to the point of issuing lawsuits and pistols at dawn. The subject was weighed down heavily with strutting prima donnas all wanting a large slice of the pie. Andrews, Delgado, Wingfield and last but definitely not least, Green, revelled in the media attention, loving the adoration of 'their' public.

With the deflation of crop circle popularity, the publication of a new book on the subject would seem a preposterous suggestion - a book destined for the remainder graveyard. All those tedious measurements, endless scientific (or pseudo-scientific) narratives, with the Hopi Indians popping up for a pow wow to add effect and more to the ratings!

However, "Round in Circles" by Jim Schnabel is a book that should be read by everyone interested in the subject, as it pulls the rug sharply from under the feet of all the self-appointed gurus of the crop circle myth. This book is not about the circles themselves, but the people who researched and promoted them - the laughs, the cries, the tantrums and the gullibility of those who loved to bathe in the limelight, but disappeared into obscurity after the Doug and Dave revelations burst the bubble.

Schnabel has cleverly pieced together the circumstances behind the Andrews and Delgado marriage, their separations and final divorce, explains when Meaden appeared on the scene and his tortuous relationship and clashes with 'Fandango and Condres', and details the emergence of the CCCS and its New Age leader Michael Green, who is described in the book as "... tall and dignified, with vaguely exotic features - broad face, blond curly hair - that recalled both Peter Ustinov and, perhaps a little incongruously, Harpo Marx."

My favourite passage refers to the opening of the CCCS at a house in Ely, Cambridgeshire. "It was a regular country house weekend, with drinks and laughs and food everywhere ... Busty Taylor loved it. He had neither seen nor heard anything like it in his life: all these good looking old school tie people with their high-toned accents. And he was right in among them, as an honoured guest. Except he couldn't help noticing ... that when someone was needed to help in the kitchen, or to carry trays of food, or to do some spare-hand job, they would never ask John Haddington, or George Wingfield or even Richard Andrews. They would ask ... him."

In his final chapters, Schnabel lifts the lid off the secret, underground, circle hoaxing craze that gave birth to an obsession for the credulous and an opportunity for the entrepreneur, but finally killed the subject off with its own popularity.

The hilarity, the horrors and the hysteria of the crop circles fraternity are all in this well written and extremely entertaining book. A must buy - you will not be disappointed.

UFO Abductions and Technologies of Social Control

In the early days of World War II, George Estabrooks, of Colgate University, wrote to the Department of War, describing in breathless terms the possible uses of hypnosis in warfare. The Army was intrigued; Estabrooks had a job. The true history of Estabrooks' war-time collaboration with the CID, FBI and other agencies may never be told: After the war, he burned his diary pages covering the years 1940-45, and thereafter avoided discussing his continuing government work with anyone, even close members of the family. Occasionally, he strongly intimated that his work involved the creation of hypno-programmed couriers and hypnotically-induced split personalities, but whether he succeeded in these areas remains a controversial point. Nevertheless, the eccentric and flamboyant Estabrooks remains a pivotal figure in the early history of clandestine behavioural research.

The newly-formed CIA plunged into this cesspool in 1950, with Project BLUEBIRD, rechristened ARTICHOKE in 1951. To establish a 'cover story' for this research, the CIA funded a propaganda effort designed to convince the world that the Communist Bloc had devised insidious new methods of re-shaping the human will; the CIA's own efforts could therefore, if exposed, be explained as an attempt to 'catch up' with Soviet and Chinese work. The primary promoter of this 'line' was one Edward Hunter, a CIA contract employee operating under-cover as a journalist, and, later, a prominent member of the John Birch society. We now know that the entire brainwashing scare of the 1950s constituted a CIA hoax perpetrated upon the American public: CIA deputy director Richard Helms admitted as much when, in 1963, he told the Warren Commission that Soviet mind control research consistently lagged years behind American efforts.

When the CIA's mind control program was transferred from the Office of Security to the Technical Services Staff (TSS) in 1953, the name changed again -- to MKULTRA. Many consider this wide-ranging 'octopus' project -- whose tentacles twined through the corridors of numerous universities and around the necks of an army of scientists -- the most ominous operation in CIA's catalogue of atrocity. Through MKULTRA, the Agency created an umbrella program of a positively Joycean scope, designed to ferret out all possible means of invading what George Orwell once called 'the space between our ears' (Later still, in 1962, mind control research was transferred to the Office of Research and Development; project cryptonyms remain unrevealed.) Mystery still shrouds another area of study, the area which seems to have most interested the Pentagon: psychoelectronics. This research may prove the key to our understanding of the UFO abduction phenomenon.

Perhaps the most interesting pieces of evidence surrounding the abduction phenomenon are the intracerebral implants allegedly visible in the X-rays and MRI scans of many abductees. Indeed, abductees often describe operations in which needles are inserted into the brain; more frequently still, they report implantation of foreign objects through the sinus cavities. Many abduction specialists assume that these intracranial incursions must be the handiwork of scientists from the stars. Unfortunately, these researchers have failed to familiarise themselves with certain little-heralded advances in terrestrial technology, for the abductees' implants strongly suggest a technological lineage which can be traced to a device known as a 'stimoceiver,' invented in the late '50s-early '60s by a neuroscientist named José 'Bob' Delgado. The stimoceiver is a miniature depth electrode which can receive and transmit electronic signals over FM radio waves. By stimulating a correctly-positioned stimoceiver, an outside operator can wield a surprising degree of control over the subject's responses.

The most famous example of the stimoceiver in action occurred in a Madrid bull ring. Delgado 'wired' the bull before stepping into the ring, entirely unprotected. Furious for gore, the bull charged toward the doctor -- then stopped, just before reaching him. The technician-turned-toreador had halted the animal by simply pushing a button on a black box held in the hand. Delgado's PHYSICAL CONTROL OF THE MIND: TOWARD A PSYCHOCIVILISED SOCIETY remains the sole, full-length, popularly-written work on intracerebral implants and electronic stimulation of the brain (ESB).

Of one experimental subject, Delgado notes that 'the patient expressed the successive sensations of fainting, fright and floating around. These 'floating' feelings were repeatedly evoked on different days by stimulation of the same point...' Ufologists may recognise the similarity of this sequence of events to abductee reports of the opening minutes of their experiences. Under subsequent hypnosis, the abductee could be instructed to misremember the cause of this floating sensation.

In a fascinating series of experiments, Delgado attached the stimoceiver to the tympanic membrane, thereby transforming the ear into a sort of microphone, so the ramifications of this technology may go even deeper. I presume that if a suitably-wired subject's inner ear can be made into a microphone, it can also be made into a loudspeaker -- one possible explanation for the 'voices' heard by abductees. Indeed, I have personally viewed a strange, opalescent implant within the ear canal of an abductee. I see no reason to ascribe this device to alien intrusion -- more than likely, the 'intruders' in this case were the technological inheritors of the Delgado legacy. Robert G. 'Bob' Heath, of Tulane University, who has implanted as many as 125 electrodes in his subjects, achieved his greatest notoriety by attempting to 'cure' homosexuality through ESB. In his experiments, he discovered that he could control his patients' memory, (a feat which, applied in the ufological context, may account for the phenomenon of 'missing time'); he could also induce sexual arousal, fear, pleasure, and hallucinations.

Perhaps the most disturbing wanderer into this mind-field is Joseph A. Meyer, of the National Security Agency, the most formidable and secretive component of America's national security complex. Meyer has proposed implanting roughly half of all Americans arrested -- not necessarily convicted -- of any crime; the numbers of 'subscribers' (his euphemism) would run into the tens of millions. 'Subscribers' could be monitored continually by computer wherever they went. Meyer, who has carefully worked out the economics of his mass-implantation system, asserts that taxpayer liability should be reduced by forcing subscribers to 'rent' the implant from the State. Implants are cheaper and more efficient than police, Meyer suggests, since the call to crime is relentless for the poor 'urban dweller' -- who, this spook-scientist admits in a surprisingly candid aside, is fundamentally unnecessary to a post-industrial economy.

If we are to take seriously abductee accounts of brain implants, we must consider the possibility that the implanters, properly perceived, DON'T look much like the 'greys' pictured on Strieber's dustjackets. Instead, the visitors may resemble Dr. Meyer and his brethren. We would thus have an explanation for both the reports of abductee brain implants and, as we shall see, the 'scoop marks' and other scars visible on other parts of the abductees' bodies. We would also have an explanation for the reports of individuals suffering personality change after contact with the UFO phenomenon. Sceptics might counter that the time factor of UFO abductions disallows this possibility. If estimates of 'missing time' are correct, the abductions rarely take longer than one-to-three hours. Wouldn't a brain surgeon, operating under less-than-ideal conditions (perhaps in a mobile unit) need more time?

No -- not if we accept the claims of a Florida doctor named Daniel

Man. He recently proposed a draconian solution to the overblown 'missing children problem,' by suggesting a programme wherein America's youngsters would be implanted with tiny transmitters in order to track the children continuously. Man brags that the operation can be done right in the office -- and would take less than 20 minutes. Conceivably, it might take a tad longer in the field.

I make an issue of the timing and secrecy involved in this research to underscore three points: 1. We can never know with certainty the true origin dates of the various brainwashing methods -- often, we discover that techniques which seem impossibly futuristic actually originated in the 19th century. (Pioneering ESB research was conducted in 1898, by J.R. ('Bob' Dobbs) Ewald, professor of physiology at Strausbourg.) 2. The open literature almost certainly gives a bowdlerised view of the actual research. 3. Lavishly-funded clandestine researchers -- unrestrained by peer review or the need for strict controls -- can achieve far more rapid progress than scientists 'on the outside.' Potential critics should keep these points in mind should they attempt to invalidate the 'mind control' thesis of UFO abductions by citing an abduction account which antedates Delgado.

So why -- if we take UFO abduction accounts at face value -- are the 'advanced aliens' using an old technology, an EARTH technology, a technology which may soon be rendered obsolescent, if it hasn't been so rendered already? I am reminded of the charming anachronisms in the old Flash Gordon serials, where swords and spaceships clashed continually.

Over the years, certain journalists have asserted that the CIA has mastered a technology called RHIC-EDOM. RHIC means 'Radio Hypnotic Intracerebral Control.' EDOM stands for 'Electronic Dissolution of Memory.' Together, these techniques can -- allegedly -- remotely induce hypnotic trance, deliver suggestions to the subject, and erase all memory for both the instruction period and the act which the subject is asked to perform.

RHIC uses the stimoceiver, or a microminiaturized offspring of that technology to induce a hypnotic state. Interestingly, this technique is also reputed to involve the use of INTRAMUSCULAR implants, a detail strikingly reminiscent of the 'scars' mentioned in Budd Hopkins MISSING TIME. Apparently, these implants are stimulated to induce a post-hypnotic suggestion. EDOM is nothing more than missing time itself -- the erasure of memory from consciousness through the blockage of synaptic transmission in certain areas of the brain. By jamming the brain's synapses through a surfeit of acetochole, neural transmission along selected pathways can be effectively stilled. According to the proponents of RHIC-EDOM, acetochole production can be affected by electromagnetic means. (Modern research in the psycho-physiological effects of microwaves confirm this proposition.)

Robert Anton Wilson, an author with a devoted cult following, recently has taken to promoting a new generation of 'mind machines' designed to promote creativity, stimulate learning, and alter consciousness -- i.e., provide a drug-less high. Interestingly, these machines can also induce 'Out-of-Body- Experiences,' in which the percipient mentally 'travels' to another location while his body remains at rest. This rapidly-developing technology has spawned a technological equivalent to the drug culture; indeed, the aficionados of the electronic buzz even have their own magazine, REALITY HACKERS. [Now defunct.] I strongly suspect that we will hear much of these machines in the future.

One such device is called the 'hemi-synch.' This headphone-like invention produces slightly different frequencies in each ear; the brain calculates the difference between these frequencies, resulting in a rhythm known as the 'binaural beat.' The brain 'entrains' itself to this beat -- that is, the subject's EEG slows down or speeds up to keep pace with its electronic running partner. The brain has a 'beat' of its

own.

I have spoken to several UFO abductees who describe a 'stereophonic sound' effect -- EXACTLY SIMILAR TO THAT PRODUCED BY THE HEMI-SYNCH -- preceding many 'encounters.' Of course, one usually administers the hemi-synch via headphones, but I see no reason why the effect cannot be transmitted via the above-described stimoceiver. Again, I remind the reader of the abductee with an implant just inside her ear canal.

An interview with an informant named Joseph Light elicited some particularly provocative revelations. According to Light:

There are important elements in the scientific community, powerful people, who are very much interested in these areas... but they have to keep most of their work secret. Because as soon as they start to publish some of these sensitive things, they have problems in their lives. You see, they work on research grants, and if you follow the research being done, you find that as soon as these scientists publish something about this, their research funds are cut off. There are areas in bioelectric research where very simple techniques and devices can have mind-boggling effects. Conceivably, if you have a crazed person with a bit of a technical background, he can do a lot of damage.

Perhaps the most ominous revelations, however, concern the mysterious work of J.F. 'BoB' Schapitz, who in 1974 filed a plan to explore the interaction of radio frequencies and hypnosis. He proposed the following:

In this investigation it will be shown that the spoken word of the hypnotist may be conveyed by modulated electro-magnetic energy DIRECTLY INTO THE SUBCONSCIOUS PARTS OF THE HUMAN BRAIN [my italics] -- i.e., without employing any technical devices for receiving or transcoding the messages and without the person exposed to such influence having a chance to control the information input consciously. He outlined an experiment, innocent in its immediate effects yet chilling in its implications, whereby subjects would be implanted with the subconscious suggestion to leave the lab and buy a particular item; this action would be triggered by a certain cue word or action. Schapitz felt certain that the subjects would rationalise the behaviour -- in other words, the subject would seize upon any excuse, however thin, to chalk up his actions to the working of free will[86]. His instincts on this latter point coalesce perfectly with findings of professional hypnotists[87].

Schapitz's work was funded by the Department of Defence. Despite FOIA requests, the results have never been publicly revealed.

Another point worth mentioning concerns the combination of EMR and miniature brain electrodes. The father of the stimoceiver, Dr. J.M.R. 'Bob' Delgado, has recently conducted experiments in which monkeys are exposed to electromagnetic fields, thereby eliciting a wide range of behavioural effects -- one monkey might fly into a volcanic rage while, just a few feet away, his simian partner begins to nod off. Fascinatingly, when monkeys with brain implants felt 'the wave,' the effects were greatly intensified. Apparently, these tiny electrodes can act as AMPLIFIERS of the electromagnetic effect[92].

This last point is important to our 'alien abduction' thesis. Critics might counter that any burst of microwave energy powerful enough to have truly remote effects would probably also create a thermal reaction. That is, if a clandestine operator propagated a 'wave' from outside an abductee's bedroom (say, from a low-flying helicopter, or from a truck travelling alongside the subject's car), the power necessary to do the job might be such that the microwave would cook the target before it got a chance to launder his thoughts. Our abductee would end up like the victim of the microwave 'hit' in the finale of Jerzy Kozinsky's COCKPIT.

It's a fair criticism. But Delgado's work may give us our solution. Once an abductee has been implanted -- and if we are to trust hypnotic

regression accounts of abductees at all, the first implanting session may occur in childhood -- the chip-in-the-brain would act as an intensifier of the signal. Such an individual could have any number of 'UFO' experiences while his or her bed partner dozes comfortably.


Furthermore, recent reports indicate that a 'waver' can achieve pin-point accuracy without the use of Delgado-style implants. In 1985, volunteers at the Midwest Research Institute in Kansas City, Missouri, were exposed to microwave beams as part of an experiment sponsored by the Department of Energy and the New York State Department of Health. As THE ARIZONA REPUBLIC[93] described the experiment, 'A matched control group sat IN THE SAME ROOM without being bombarded by non-ionising radiation.' [My italics.] Apparently, one can focus 'the wave' quite narrowly -- a fact which has wide implications for abductees.

EDITOR'S NOTE:

The foregoing is excerpted from a long article by an American scientist. It does not of course follow that, if terrestrial scientists can manipulate minds, we are therefore mistaken in the belief that Ufonauts can do it too. On the contrary, it should render the powers ascribed to Ufonauts more credible. In short, even if the description of the researches alleged here to have been carried out by the American intelligence community is correct, it neither confirms nor disproves the abduction accounts currently being studied by ufologists world wide. One might, however, ask whether the powers claimed for the CIA et al. are also shared by other governments, and if so did they develop them independently? Furthermore, early abduction cases such as those of Villas Boas and Herbert Schirmer do not match the syndrome hypothesised here.

Concerning the validity of the mind control experiments described, we have no way of assessing it, and since our prime concern was in connection with abduction experiences, we omitted many references offered in its support. True or false, we do not feel that proof of the postulated terrestrial mental control has been given, nor indeed would we expect to find it in matters classified above top secret. Its existence remains, therefore, an open question pending the production of conclusive evidence either way.





OPERATION WHITE COW by Ron Baskerville

ONE day, predicts paranormal researcher John Spencer, school-children will wander into PK and ESP classes with as much nonchalance as they file into RE and PT today.

PK? ESP? Psychokinesis and Extra-Sensory Perception, of course. And if you think that's so odd it could never come about, imagine a medieval teacher grappling with the idea of giving lessons on video.

John Spencer's point is that much of what we call the paranormal today may one day be understood and taken for granted.

Psychic healing, premonition, clairvoyance, telepathy, spirit messages, dowsing, crop circles, crystal energy, out-of-body experiences, UFOs — all of these will still spark some odd

looks if brought into conversation.

But there's also hardly anyone who doesn't have a personal view on them one way or another — which goes to show that even the sophisticated 90s are as fascinated by the unknown as any superstitious peasant of old.

Once people told stories of meeting fairies and being taken off to Fairyland. Now they tell of meeting aliens and being whisked off to new planets in mysterious spacecraft.

It's much the same thing, says John Spencer, the author of a new book *The Paranormal: A Modern Perspective*.

"Perhaps this is the result of our science fiction culture," he says.

"Celtic writings have 'fairie-

folk' who took children, and often adults, into fairy rings where they would suffer missing time experiences similar to those of modern UFO abductees."

In fact, says John Spencer, he'd stick his neck right out and say that it's possible there never have been UFO abductions in the way we have come to read reports of them in the tabloid press.

"I think the reports have been described by the people of the time in the terms they could understand.

"The true meaning of these experiences may be misunderstood by one or the other culture; most likely no-one has yet found the right way to understand these experiences."
