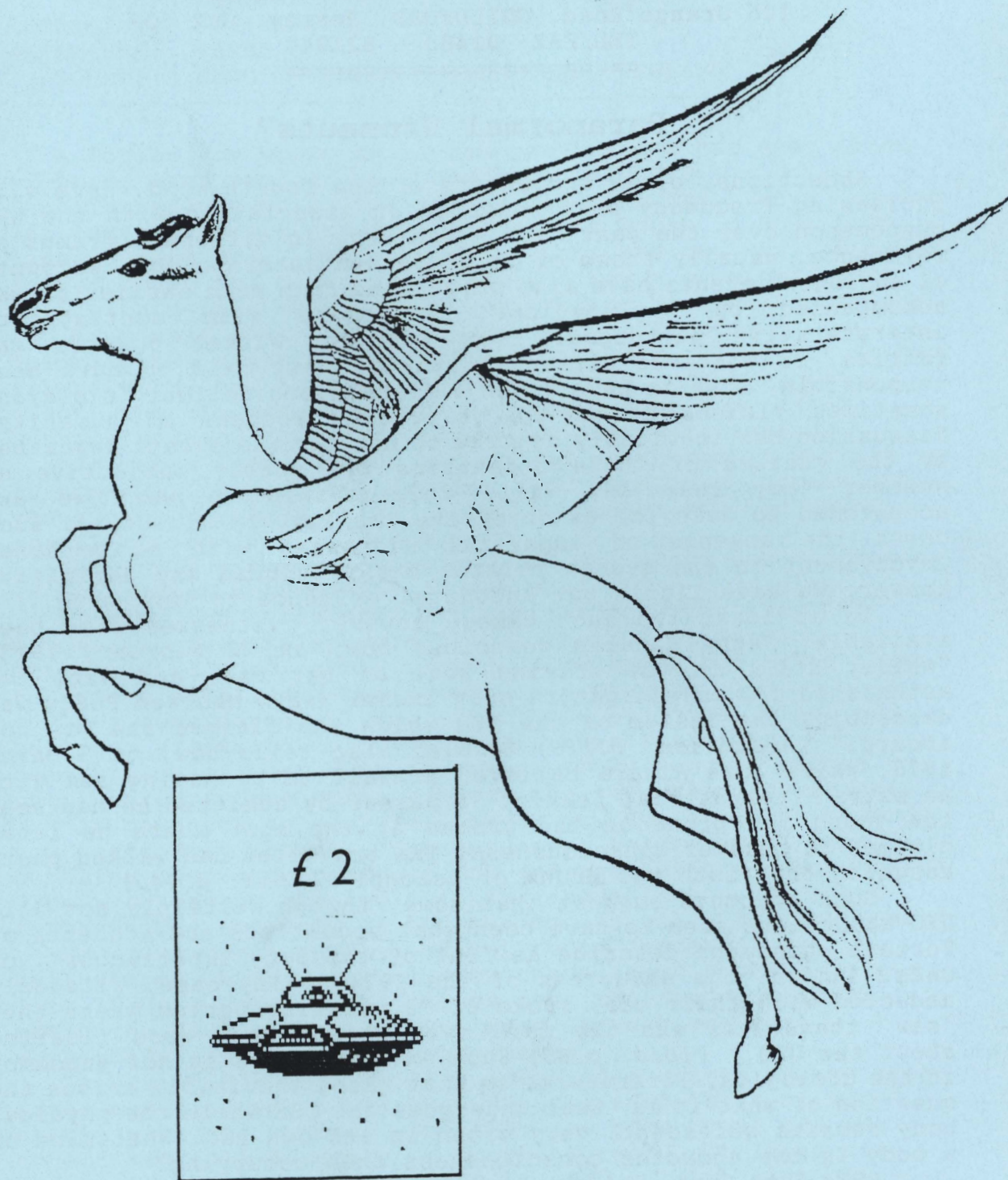

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Paranormal Ufonauts?

Abductions, close encounters of the fourth kind, have with increasing frequency been reported in association with the UFO phenomenon over the past half - century. In different frames of reference, usually those of folklore and anthropology, accounts of analogous events have also originated from much earlier times, accompanied by explanations in accord with contemporary interpretative paradigms. From Rip van Winkel onwards the fairies, or whatever elemental spirits were held to have been responsible, seem to have taken a mischievous delight in playing sometimes vicious tricks on selected specimens of humanity. Discussion has inevitably centred on how far the events described by the victims of these attentions are purely subjective or whether they bear any valid relationship to what we are accustomed to describe as objective reality. In almost all such cases the absence of impartial witnesses with no personal involvement in the events related has precluded any definitive answer. We have little but anecdotal evidence to work with.

In at least two such cases, however, witnesses have been available. Jenny Randles describes how, on 22 February 1973, "whilst still in the driving seat of her car, and with two astonished UFO investigators only inches away, Maureen Puddy was describing the inside of the UFO which she claimed she was now aboard." (*Abduction*, p.129) Randles also tells how, on 3 March 1978, while José Alvaro believed himself to be having sex with an extra - terrestrial female, "a passer by admitted he had seen the young man prone on the ground at the spot where he later claimed to recover consciousness. The traveller had walked past, assuming the youth was drunk or asleep." (*Ibid.* p.140)

Such accounts suggest that some, though certainly not all, UFO abductions seem to have been what occultists and students of Fortean phenomena describe as "Out of the Body Experiences", or OBEs. Indeed, the abductees of the 1974 Aveley case, allegedly abducted with their car, spoke of "a puzzling period where they 'saw' themselves and the car, even though they were floating about the UFO." (*Ibid.* p.80) Such an experience is not uncommon in the ufological literature, so that there inevitably arises the question of what it is that undergoes the OBE while the physical body remains quiescent, very often in its own bed. What kind of a body is the abducted consciousness then occupying?

OBEs are not, of course, uniquely experienced by UFO abductees - they have often been reported by people undergoing surgery under anaesthesia, especially when near to death. Occultists, however, claim to be able to evoke the experience at

will, transferring their consciousness intentionally into what they call the astral body.

According to Fred Gettings (*Encyclopaedia of the Occult, Guild Publishing 1986*), "The astral body is seen by clairvoyants as having an independent existence on the astral plane during periods when the physical body is asleep or when a person consciously indulges in astral travel. During such periods of conscious travel and during ordinary sleep (or in the case of an imposed trance) it is quite natural for the astral body to leave the physical and etheric bodies behind and to lead an independent existence on its proper plane of being ..." He adds that this astral plane "is contiguous in space (if not in time) with the material realm", which might account for the five days said to have been lost by Corporal Valdes in fifteen minutes of normal time in Arica, Chile on 25 April 1977, or the similar length of time claimed as lost by Travis Walton two years previously in Snowflake, Arizona.

Moreover, if the astral plane is contiguous in space with our everyday world, we do not need to invoke the extra-terrestrial hypothesis (ETH) of UFO origins to explain the incursions of some of its denizens into the frequency band we normally inhabit. The entity claimed to have visited Cynthia Appleton in Birmingham on several occasions in the 1950s told her that scientists trying to reach his place of origin would fail because they were "... pulling against the great force of gravity by going straight up ..." (ETH?), when they should "travel with a sideways attitude." (A frequency shift above the ultra-violet or below the infra-red? The alleged statement of a putative astral entity filtered through the consciousness of a Birmingham housewife can be expected to be somewhat gnostic!)

There is evidence to suggest that some abductees are not randomly selected but require to have a certain psychic sensitivity which is perhaps a pre-requisite for making this postulated frequency shift to the astral. Betty Andreasson's account of her alleged abduction by Strieber-type entities on 25 January 1967 at South Ashburnham, Massachusetts refers to her family being frozen into suspended animation, possibly because they lacked the psychic constitution which alone permits manipulation in this way.

Budd Hopkins reports in *Intruders* a similar case of familial immobilisation. After undergoing what has become virtually the standard physical examination (*Sachs - The UFO Encyclopaedia 1980*), Andreasson claimed to have been conducted through a series of alien realms where she encountered strange and sometimes symbolic creatures and events, similar in many ways to descriptions by occultists of travels in the astral body. Aleister Crowley (*Magick, Guild Publishing, p.258*) wrote that "this fine body perceives a universe which we do not ordinarily perceive ..." and which "... is naturally fitted to perceive objects of its own class ... in particular the phantoms of the astral plane."

He also warned against uncritical acceptance of any statements such entities may make, for "every spirit, up to God himself, is ready to deceive you if possible, to make himself out more important than he is..." (*Ibid. p.260*). Perhaps this may account for some of the incredible extra-terrestrial origins said to have been claimed by some uninvited visitants? Crowley also warned of the dangers of mishandling this return to the physical

body - "If you fail to do this properly you may find yourself in serious trouble. Your Body of Light may wander away uncontrolled, and be attacked and obsessed. You will become aware of this through the occurrence of headache, bad dreams or even more serious signs such as hysteria, fainting fits, possibly madness or paralysis" - (*Ibid.* p.260)

These are precisely the kind of symptoms described by Whitley Strieber (*Communion*) and others, following their abduction experiences. Indeed, considering the ruthless lack of concern for their victims' welfare evinced by this small, bug-eyed variety of ufonauts, it is perhaps a tribute to their powers of mental manipulation that they can still be perceived by their victims as essentially non-malevolent. It is this mental control apparently exercised by some of our extra-dimensional visitors that renders all anecdotal evidence suspect. We literally cannot trust the sensory impressions presented to the victims' minds.

UFOs appeared in medieval times as sailing ships, as dirigible airships at the time the Zeppelins were under development and as cigars, triangles or saucers ever since the foo fighters of World War II. Most entities described may be divided into two major categories of golden-haired, blue-eyed humanoids and bug eyed midgets, but the three women allegedly abducted near the Wrekin in July 1981 gave totally different descriptions of presumably the same abductors! Are the agents of the Phenomenon then able, as is often claimed, to present themselves and their vehicles to human eyes in any form they deem expedient?

In the ages of faith before the scientific revolution in human thinking such questions naturally did not arise - anything that could not be accommodated within contemporary intellectual and emotional paradigms was *ipso facto* evil or illusory, a work of the devil and therefore to be cast out. When medieval peasants who had seen ufonauts descend from a space vehicle went in a body to their bishop, he told them that such a happening was impossible and that they had seen no such thing. They believed him on authority and against the evidence of their own eyes, but maybe the bishop was not so stupid after all. Faith - any sort of faith, however misguided - is a sure shield against psychic manipulation. We sceptics to-day are far more vulnerable - we cannot look for spells from the local warlock in yellow pages, or drop in on the priestess of a nearby coven with a request for some protective wicca-power. Maybe modern victims should try flooding the house with garlic, wearing amulets and describing pentagrams around their beds. Such defences were once deemed effective - empirically, they should be worth a try!

LINDA CORTILE'S EXPERIENCE

From the Paranet UFO echo:

On or about the evening of November 30, 1989, at approximately 3:15 AM, Linda (last name withheld) was asleep in her apartment on the 12th floor of an apartment building in New York City, together with her husband and two young sons. She made contact with Budd Hopkins and under hypnosis reported being levitated off her bed, approached by three grey aliens, and transported with them through her apartment wall out above the street and then up into a floating disk. She reported that she sensed her nightgown being drawn up to her face.

A few weeks later, Dan (last name withheld) wrote a letter to Hopkins, stating that he and his partner Richard (last name withheld) had witnessed the event from a car parked on the street about a block away. He described a young woman and three small grey creatures emerging from the side of the building at the 12th floor in a fetal position, arms wrapped around their legs, head up, with one creature above the woman and the other two below and to each side. After emerging from the side of the building, their bodies extended and they were then lifted up and into the floating disk, which was described as having an orange glowing topside, with yellow illumination extending down and outward, except for a narrow bluish beam extending straight downward up which the four figures were lifted. Dan reported that after the figures entered the craft, it then moved over and down into the river (name withheld by author) and never reappeared. Dan described himself and Richard as "undercover policemen" who would not publicly come forward for fear of damaging their careers. Dan said they were both extremely upset by the incident, fearing for the life or safety of the young woman, and distressed that they had been unable to do anything to help her. Dan stated that he and Richard would attempt to visit the apartment from which Linda had been taken to see what became of her.

Having no way to contact Dan or Richard, Hopkins read their letter to Linda, advising her that they might visit her, and asking her to ask them to contact him again if they did.

Dan and Richard then went to Linda's apartment, and when they identified themselves, Linda told them Hopkins had told her to expect them. Dan and Richard were very relieved that Linda was seemingly okay, and Linda expressed mixed feelings, saying that it might have been easier to accept being crazy than having it be confirmed that it really happened.

Dan and Richard did not agree to visit Hopkins, but Linda did get them to agree to send Hopkins an audiotape giving a more detailed account of the events of November 30, and a few days later Hopkins did receive the audiotape, which he played for the MUFON audience. Dan reported that Richard was so concerned about Linda that he had taken to observing her and her apartment during off hours to make sure she was okay.

In the meantime, Linda developed discomfort in her right nostril and visited her physician, who took an Xray. A day or two later, before the Xray was developed and returned, Linda woke up with blood over her face and bedding from her right nostril. The Xray was shown to the MUFON audience. It clearly showed a cylindrical radio-opaque object, perhaps 2-4 mm in length, with a helical pointed extension off each end and to one side. Subsequent examination showed no object present and under hypnosis it came out that Linda had been visited again by aliens and the object removed.

In the meantime, Hopkins tried to identify Dan and Richard. Then he was contacted by a woman who reported that she had been driving on a major New York bridge (name withheld by author) on the evening of November 30, 1989,

together with a few other cars, when her vehicle stopped, together with all electrical activity. She then noticed an orange glow and saw a glowing disk floating above and to the side of an apartment building near the bridge. She saw a young woman and three small grey creatures emerge from the side of the building, from an upper floor about the level of the bridge, in fetal position, then extend before lifting up into the disk along a blue beam. She also reported that people in other stalled vehicles also saw the incident. After the disk left, her car's dome light came on again and she was able to restart her car and leave the area.

When asked to remember the event and count off the number of seconds it took from the time the figures emerged from the side of the building to the time they unfolded, the witness estimated x seconds (number withheld by author).

In the meantime, Dan and Richard accosted Linda on the street, asking her to come with them. When she refused, they took her by force to another location and interrogated her. They seemed particularly concerned about whether she could tell them whether the aliens had known about the men witnessing the event. They also removed her shoes and examined her feet, seeking confirmation that she was human, because they thought aliens had no toes.

Under hypnosis, Linda was able to give Hopkins the license number of one of the vehicles used in arresting her and part of the license number of the other. From that and other investigation, Hopkins was able to learn that they are not policemen, but US government agents. The men further revealed to Linda that at the time of the incident, their car had been moving and lost power, and that they had a third party with them, a high public official who they were escorting, who also witnessed the incident. They excused their own abduction of her as a matter of "national security".

Hopkins reported that he has been able to obtain a photograph of one of the two men, knows their identities and their agency, and knows the identity of the high public official who was with them.

Hopkins further reported on some other visits to Linda and her family. It turned out that her youngest son had been similarly abducted from their apartment several months before the events of November 30, 1989. And during a later overnight visit by a young family friend, Linda, her husband, two sons, and their guest all awoke with severe nosebleeds from their right nostrils.

One of the two men also provided a drawing, which closely resembled one done by the witness on the bridge, and also resembled one done by the son of Linda who had been abducted. One of the men also estimated that the duration from emergence to unfolding was about x seconds (same number reported by bridge witness).

Hopkins then produced Linda, who further elaborated on her experiences and answered questions from the audience.

In subsequent remarks and remarks to the author in private, Budd Hopkins said he hoped that more witnesses would come forward, and that the public official would come forward, if not in public then at least to privately contact him. He confirmed that he is withholding a number of details that he will use to verify the authenticity of any witness accounts he may receive.

Linda appears to be in her mid-30s, slender, attractive, about 5'6", with long brown hair, an Italian-American Catholic whose boys go to parochial schools.

Arch-debunker Phil Klass was very careful to get a good photograph of Linda.

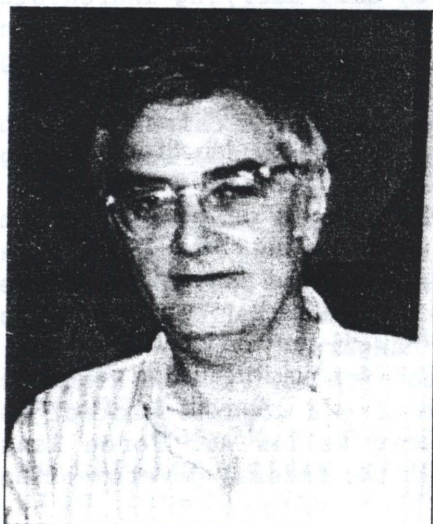
The author asked Hopkins whether he had taken precautions to make sure the facts come out in case anything happens to him. Hopkins is recovering from a recent operation, but says he is now feeling fine. He assured the author he has thought about the problem and that was the reason he decided to take the

matter public at this time. He said he is trying to get a more complete report published in the New York Post, so readers should look for it there. If any mishap should befall Hopkins, or any attempt be made to silence or discredit him, readers should not fail to ask penetrating questions about the matter.

This case is significant because there have heretofore been few cases of abductions witnessed by persons who were not among the abducted. Hopkins expressed the opinion that the event may, at least in part, have been staged for the benefit of the public figure who witnessed it.

The feelings of some in the audience may have later been summarized by Shelley ..., one of the attendees, who said "God, I hope it's not Dan Quayle!"

AUGUST IN DREAMLAND

More than 60 campers gathered on a Lincoln County mountaintop this past weekend for a typical tent-fumbling, fire building, weenie roasting kind of campout. Except for a few minor details.

Like the view 12 miles to the west of a secret air base that doesn't officially exist. And the camouflaged security police monitoring the group from nearby ridges with high-tech telescopes and night vision cameras. There were also signs, just 1,000 feet from the campsite, warning "use of deadly force authorized" should one of the campers have accidentally wandered across the base's border while searching for some firewood.

Faced with such obstacles, where else but on a ridge overlooking the military's secret Groom Lake, Area 51, or "Dreamland" testing facility would aviation buffs, government watchdogs, alien abductees, conspiracy theorists, filmmakers, reporters, marijuana-smoking slackers, card-carrying anarchists, socialists and libertarians, a Lincoln County commissioner and a conch-blowing religious zealot and his second cousin so peacefully come together on a craggy peak for a weekend in the great outdoors?

"Only on Freedom Ridge," said Groom Lake gadfly Glenn Campbell of the public high ground he christened two years ago that offers the best vantage point of the secret base.

Campbell, the author of "The Area 51 Visitor's Guide" and publisher of "The Groom Lake Desert Rat" newsletter, organized the weekend-long "Groomstock" as a protest and last hurrah before the Air Force extends the base's restricted zone by 3972 acres to prevent gawkers like himself from stealing glimpses of its seven mile runway and haze of buildings and hangars.

Last September, Air Force officials filed to withdraw Freedom Ridge and nearby White Sides Mountain from public lands, citing a need to protect the safe and secure operation of the 3.5 million acre Nellis Air Force Range complex. The range includes the secret base, which the federal government has never acknowledged exists.

A decision by Interior Secretary Bruce Babbitt on whether to lock up the additional land is at least six months away, Bureau of Land Management officials said Friday. During this weekend's campout, opinions about the withdrawal varied as much as reasons that led campers to the mountain ridge in the first place.

A few who believe the military uses the secret base to hide alien spacecraft or conduct genetic tests on abducted children opposed the withdrawal on grounds that it would keep them from monitoring clandestine activities. For most, however, viewing the base is less important than answering questions about it. Although Campbell and his minions have resigned themselves to the likelihood of the withdrawal, they question the government's need for absolute secrecy in this post Cold War era.

"If they would just act like responsible adults and fess up to what they're doing out there, that would satisfy most of the curiosity," said Tom Mahood, a civil engineer from Irvine, Calif. "The military doesn't have to treat civilians like we're the enemy, especially when it's our tax dollars paying for it."

Originally built in the early 1950's to test the Lockheed U-2, the Groom Lake base has been used to test high-altitude, high-speed spy planes and other military aircraft, including the F-117A Stealth fighter, according to aviation industry sources and witnesses who have observed the installation.

The base has sparked particular controversy this year, including two citizen action lawsuits filed earlier this month on behalf of workers who

allegedly suffered from illegal and unregulated open-air burning of toxic materials. Also in three incidents since March, Lincoln County sheriff's deputies have detained news crews suspected of illegally filming the installation.

In snubs to base officials, the campers directed phony cameras at the base, organized a stadium-style wave for the military police observing them from opposite ridges and posted signs along the road to Freedom Ridge where guards placed covert road sensors.

Then, on Saturday evening, when the sun went down and their protests were over, the campers kicked back around the campfire to toast marshmallows, gab about "black world" spy planes and UFO abductions and gaze into the clear night sky, transfixed, searching for a glimpse of something, anything inexplicable.

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NIBIRU, ZIUSUDRA AND ALL THAT

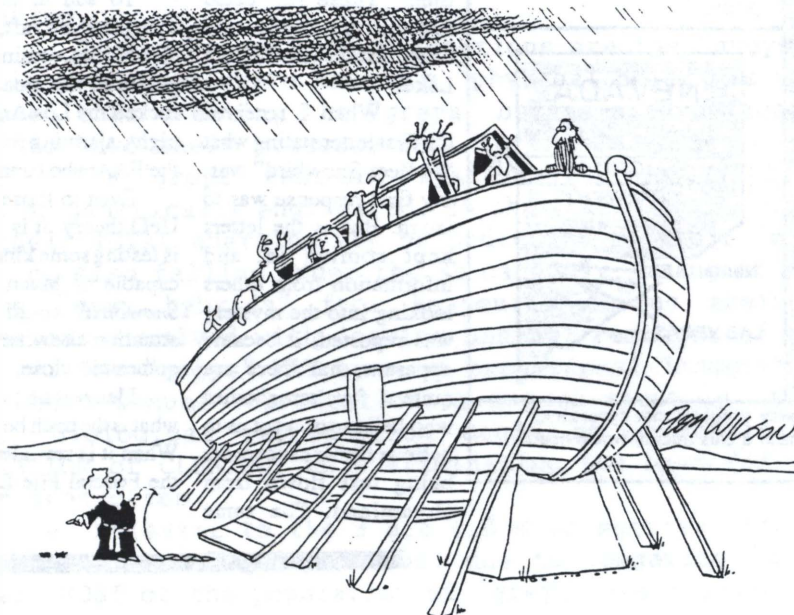

bizarre story has surfaced from many sources, including the national press.

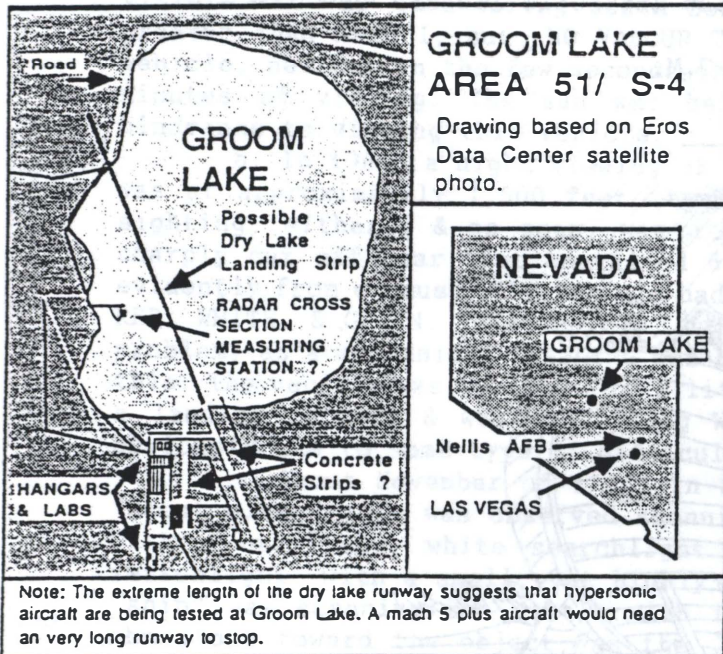

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THE GREYS

Based on other's observations, personal experience, conjecture, & hypothesis, the following is presented.

A. "Greys" as alien life forms exhibit:

1. No viewable ears.
2. No viewable nose.
3. Very small mouth.
4. Very large eyes, with large & dark appearing pupils.
5. Very large cranium, with perspective to the rest of the body.
6. Adult size is small, approximately 3 (three) feet in height.
7. Off white/grey skin or outer covering.
8. No apparent sexual organs. Reproduction is, evidently, either asexual or non-existent.

B. Synopsis:

1. With no visible ears or nose, with large eyes & cranium, it would appear that there is a dependency to sense through the abilities of sight, touch, & MENTAL POWERS (this may include the talent to communicate using a form of thought transference).

2. Bodily functioning, evidently, IS NOT dependent on breathing, as NOT having a visible nose & a VERY small mouth would seem to point out. Either that, or there are other breathing dynamics involved. Instead, if gases are required for proper functioning, they COULD be absorbed through the skin.

3. Because of the lack of sexual organs, either:

a. The "greys" are creations of another species.

1. Because of the "sexless" nature of "greys", they MIGHT be the genetic engineering creation of a species more advanced than ever thought of by humankind.

2. The beings, whose creations are the "greys", MAY have come to a point in evolution where having a "physical being" is unnecessary in order to survive, thus creating the "greys" became a advantageous step for them in order to have their presence felt in the Universe.

b. The "greys" that are "space travellers" MAY have been surgically altered, or genetically engineered, so that their sexual urges are eliminated, & thus their TOTAL energies may be dedicated to their "mission".

c. Also falling under the 3b category, being of a neutered sex would eliminate "grey hybrids" from happening during their "missions" & the repercussions involved with leaving behind remnants of an encounter.

d. The "greys" MAY have an exceptional longevity & have evolved to a point where sexual reproduction is non-existent in the sense that humans know it. Biological reproduction could be carried out with IN-VITRO FERTILIZATION or CLONING, thus eliminating the need for physical encounters during reproduction.

e. Relevant to the 3 a,b,c,& d categories, the "greys" might have amassed too large of a population, due to longevity & to counter further increases. MOST of the population of "greys" are sterile, SIMILAR to the way that worker bees are made as opposed to drones & the queen bee.

4. Large & dark eyes may be caused by the "greys" evolving in an area where their sun(s) are at a MUCH greater distance from them than ours is from us; thus, they need to have greater ocular abilities to perceive light. The dark colour of the eye MAY be some kind of artificial sunglass type of utensil

needed when "operations" require them to be in the vicinity of visible radiations. The distance from a central sun(s) would seem to be evidenced by the "greys" smallish stature, in relation to a grown human, as being further away from a central sun(s) would make those inhabitants less bulky IF the planet that those beings were on was to be of a great distance away from that sun(s) AND if the planet they were inhabiting was to be of a size similar to Earth.

5. Having a VERY small oral cavity would seem to give evidence of either little or no need to intake nourishment through this means &/or of the need for normal voice communication. The lack of need for this cavity is evidenced by its small size. Future evolutionary developments in this species might include the TOTAL elimination of this organ as the ability to communicate telepathically would seem to be a FAR superior form.

C. Sightings:

1. There are sightings of a multitude of differently constructed vehicles which are, evidently, "scout class" ships (a smaller type of vehicle), but there is ALWAYS the same shape for a "Mother" ship. This shape is a VERY large CIGAR shaped vehicle.

a. Viewing a "Mother" ship in daylight (1989), with the shape being caught in a reflection of sunlight through reddish coloured clouds as the sun was setting, & at a height of approximately 2,500 feet (although there was NO point of reference to confirm this with), showed the hull to have been constructed of a highly polished metallic substance with the appearance of many rectangular plates of metal. The plates were bowed & depressed. This was only visible because of the light angles involved. The dents in the ship's surface gave an impression of having buckled under great stress, as in/out shadows of light from the sun's angle through the reddish clouds enhanced the viewing of the hull's surface for the few seconds that the vehicle was visible. It was travelling South SouthEast to North NorthWest at a speed greater than Mach 1, but, NO VAPOUR TRAIL or NO NOISE was emitted from the vehicle, neither in the few seconds that it was visible, nor in the last few minutes of viewing. The sun was behind a building & was absolutely NO hindrance to viewing this vehicle.

b. In 1964, a night viewing of a "Mother" ship was seen. This vehicle was at approximately 1,500 feet (there was NO point of reference for this sighting, either), & as seen, was a LARGE CIGAR shaped hull which had a sharply cut off rear that contained 5 exhaust ports that were glowing red, evidently from exhaust. The vehicle had "running" lights, that I believe were RED, WHITE, & GREEN. This vehicle, evidently, had some type of motivational problem, as a mechanical CLANKING was heard on the ground by all who observed this. The vehicle was moving at or a little faster than an airliner going into a landing pattern & was travelling WEST to EAST. The noise produced was obviously due to some type of difficulty with its "engine".

c. About November of 1966, in South West Texas, near San Antonio, a "scout class" ship was observed scanning a herd of cattle in a remote area with a brilliant, white searchlight beam that was brighter than an arc searchlight with a small, yet highly defined area of light. While the "ship" was scanning the cattle with its searchlight, a car spotlight was shone out toward the object, as the "ship" was too far to be illuminated, Morse code was sent out (an SOS) via the spotlight. The car's 3 occupants sped away as the "ship" began to come near it. The "ship" made ABSOLUTELY no noise as it motivated towards the car. The "ship" followed the car until it reached the outskirts of San Antonio, where it climbed upwards & away at a high speed.

IS TIME TRAVEL POSSIBLE?

Common in science fiction literature is the concept of an invention that would propel the user forward or backward in time. Though very appealing in print, it would seem to violate at least one law of physics and to necessitate, besides the device to transcend time, a second device that would allow simultaneous movement through space. What I would like to do in this short essay, is describe some of the difficulties time travel presents.

The first difficulty I see is one of human recorded history. If we were to assume that at some time in the future a device to move through time is to be invented, and that it will be used, then why has not history ever recorded the arrival of a time traveller?

Given the capability to travel to far off times, what would the time traveller's motive be? To only observe events and people would, in my opinion, be a very aloof thing to do. Given the ability to talk with people of past times, it would be irresistible not to.

Why would a time traveller want to travel through time?

We all could make lists of people we would like to speak with or of events we would like to see. But, to my knowledge, there is no recorded instance of a traveller appearing who talked of moving through time and left behind knowledge of the future.

But this "negative evidence" is not conclusive. There may be physical principles at work which would prevent the traveller from interacting with others. These physical principles would prevent the traveller from ever leaving in the first place.

Every elementary student, while studying science, has run across the laws of conservation of matter and energy. Each law states that matter or energy cannot be created nor destroyed only changed into a different form.

Matter is defined as anything that takes up space and has mass. Matter can be thought of as "the stuff" of existence. Matter is made up of tiny particles called atoms. There are about 106 known different types of atoms.

The stuff that makes up you or me or anything else in the universe is discrete and individual, that is, it cannot be in two places at the same time nor can two different atoms occupy the same space.

Now, if time travel were possible, could the following ever happen:

The time machine is to be tested with a mouse to ensure it will be safe for human use. The mouse is placed in the device and it is sent five minutes into the future. The machine disappears and five minutes later the machine and mouse appear. So far so good.

It is now sent five minutes into the past. Here the first problem appears. Five minutes before you sent the mouse off to the past you did not notice a second mouse appear

securely strapped in a second time machine. The researcher did not see the mouse appear before it has left.

Even if the mouse did appear, there would be two mice, each composed of the same atoms. Again, the same matter cannot be in two places at the same time. The atoms that make up the time traveller and his machine were continuously recycled through past time. The atoms in my fingers and toes and everywhere in between were used by other organisms in other times or were locked up in the rocks, water, and air of the earth. If I were to travel back in time, my atoms would already be in use somewhere else. How could I exist then at that time?

A second problem to be faced with a working time machine is one that involves the addition of movement through space. Matter in the universe takes up space, that is, it has length, width, and depth. These are the three dimensions all matter possesses. There is also a fourth dimension. The dimension of time.

All matter exists in space and moves through time. You move through space as you go through the day. The earth and the rest of the planets and their moons, move through space as they circle the sun. The sun moves through space as it moves with the rest of the galaxy around the galactic center and, as you can imagine, the galaxy is moving through the universe. All this movement is happening simultaneously, but we are not aware of it (thank goodness, for those of us who suffer from motion sickness.)

The computation of all this relative movement is crucial for the successful rendezvous of satellites with the planets and moons they are to observe. The earth and other planets DO NOT RETURN to the same spaces as they orbit the sun. All matter in the universe, when you compute these motions, are SPIRALLING THROUGH SPACE. The orbits are not neat ellipses.

To get back to our time traveller, as he moves back in time, the earth, sun, and galaxy have all moved relative to each other. The traveller would most probably find himself out in space somewhere rather than watching the signing of the Declaration of Independence or being there for Superbowl I. The time machine would need some way of computing where the earth would be for any date in history and a means of getting there.

All this is fun to speculate upon. Though I reckon that time travel is not possible, I'm not 100% certain. I still hold out that at some time in the future the problems mentioned here will be clarified.

Someday there might be a battered old blue police box like Dr. Who's TARDIS, his Time And Relative Dimension in Space machine. The Doctor recognized the difficulties of movement through space and time, but only in story can he transport us to any point in the universe at any point in time. Until then, I can only wait out time and carry myself through space.

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COMMENT

In regard to the very outdated concept that atoms are "recycled" throughout the Universe, evidence and rational thought both refute the idea. Matter is converted back into

energy and the energy is again converted into mass on a continual basis.

As time progresses, ALL THINGS CHANGE, including the morphogenetic fields which organize all matter in its characteristic and uniquely individual form. Keely refers to this process by the analogy of stamping out 1,000 coins from the same press.

Each coin will be slightly different due to the infinite possibilities offered by the variations in the consistency of the metal in each coin, slight variations in the pressure of the press for each coin, dents, etc which can further affect the "signature" of each coin. Not to mention the influences of other waves ranging from sound to light to cosmic influences even unto planetary bodies of the system.

Indeed, Keely says that simply touching the coin will alter the "signature" of the coin. The entire concept of Sympathy as opposed to Resonance can be equated to "fine tuning" or "coarse tuning". By this definition, Sympathy tunes to the entire "signature" over a wide range of frequencies and phase relationships, while Resonance tunes to the fundamental frequency of the mass without regard for the many subtle harmonics.

The magic in the phenomena generated by Keely was due to this understanding which allowed him to build ever more sensitive mechanisms for the analysis and tuning to such complex waveforms.

Back to Time Travel, Keely states quite matter-of-factly that "TIME IS GRAVITY". He says that the flow of "gravity" into the neutral center of a mass determines the degree of time to which the mass will be affected. Note that the ruling flows will be those of the greatest mass, in other words, the Earth dictates the primary time flow for us with our mass densities presenting the secondary time flows.

As to the movement of bodies through space, there is indication that the Aether drift of the Earth would sustain a time travelling body in such a manner that it would not leave the energy domain of the ruling mass in which it resides.

Here Aether is seen as the flow of force into the neutral center of all masses which serves to aggregate and sustain the existence of the mass in the physical form. Refer to NEUTRAL1 for a better understanding of one of Keely's greatest discoveries.

High intensity magnetic (or other) fields appear capable of altering the flow of Aether into the Neutral centers of mass which therefore alters time to some degree. At this point in time, there is almost no written literature on this subject nor many reports beyond the Philadelphia Experiment which indicate the dangers or possibilities of such an experiment.

We have found in the UFO literature some fascinating indications that AGING DOES NOT OCCUR or is greatly attenuated for living organisms immersed in an inertial dampening field which comes with the territory of anti-gravity. Alleged interviews with aliens frequently report a physique indicative of a 20 to 35 year old, yet the being claims to be in excess of 1000 of "our Earth (note this) years".

Further questions on this matter directed towards the beings lead to the statement that the aging process is greatly slowed WHILE IN THE PRESENCE OF THE SHIP FIELD and that movement outside this field will subject their bodies to the aging effects of the planetary body.

THE QUEST FOR 'ALIEN IDENTITIES'

CHILD OF THE STARS—An abductee might remember being told about having a dual identity—one as the human person on Earth, and another as an extraterrestrial creature from another planet. Some feel this may represent a cosmic intermingling of species and a promise for the future.

For their part, few 'experiencers' appear to be concerned about the methods used by people who help them recover their memories. And most will tell you: for all their similarities, no two encounter reports are exactly alike. More to the point, the classic tale of 'grey aliens' and their probing medical/genetic experimentation has perhaps grown tiresome, giving away to a panoply of variations. While stories still give everyone the willies, many reports now deal with areas reflecting the 'consciousness' polemic of Mack and others. Interestingly, this 'new wave' of kinder, gentler alien beings often shows up as white, glowing - even angelic. Also readily evident in Mack's book and elsewhere are abductees expressing the idea that their relationship with the alleged aliens began before birth, inspiring some hypnotherapists to regress clients into past lives. Other paranormal components have always been there: telepathy, out-of-body experiences, visions of light, ghost-like appearances and disappearances, disembodied voices, ecstatic states. Even prophetic warnings and spiritual messages—in fact, numerous encounters revolve around specific messages the aliens apparently want to emphasize, many having to do with a cataclysmic end of the world, along with information about the experiencer's role or mission on what's portrayed as a progressively dying planet. Some are now being informed that they have dual human-alien identities. Just another facet of an illusion? Or another phase of alien intervention revealed?

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ABDUCTEE CONFABULATION

It is generally observed that all clients in therapy - and hypnotherapy especially - are influenced by the theoretical perspective embraced by their analyst. Thus, people in primal scream therapy remember their birth experience, clients of psychoanalysts produce Freudian dreams and those in past life therapy recall previous incarnations.

The hypnotic trance is a condition of heightened suggestibility wherein the beliefs and assumptions of the hypnotist cannot but influence the outcomes of the encounter. In social work practice the alleged recovery of repressed memories of childhood abuse which are shown to have no basis in fact has already achieved recognition as the False Memory Syndrome (FMS). None of this, however, necessarily supports a view of the investigator as anything other than totally honest and well - intentioned; indeed, he is himself often the principal victim of the delusion.

In the investigation of UFO abduction cases an excessive trust in the validity of hypnotically generated material has already been widely stigmatised and Frank Johnson's account of the million refugees from the mythical planet Janos wandering the universe in search of a new home was published (1980) in all good faith, but totally discredited. It should have served as a salutary warning to Harvard psychiatrist Dr. John E. Mack, whose recent (1994) work claims on its dust cover to provide details "reported in no previous books or television programmes." This, unfortunately, is indeed the case and confirmation from other investigators may not be readily forthcoming.

From hypnotic sessions with a small opportunity sample of not very representative subjects, Dr. Mack has evolved a complex ideational structure including reincarnation, transmigration of alien identities into human bodies and a prognosis of impending ecological disaster which will destroy humanity and permit the re-population of the planet with beings half human and half alien. This is seen as a logical and desirable development from the past histories of both races, facilitating the evolution of beings of more highly developed consciousness in accordance with a pre-existing master plan.

Let it be thought that the subjects providing this information were in any way psychologically abnormal, Dr. Mack offers his personal assurance of their normality and arranged for just one of them to undergo a series of recognised mental tests without, however, giving the scores. Unlike Dr. David Jacobs, to whose (1992) book he contributed a foreword, Mack does not present in evidence transcriptions of the hypnotic sessions, merely quoting occasional sentences out of context. We are expected, in short, to accept his conclusions entirely on the basis of his academic record. It is not enough.

Security police investigates "cigar" sighting by Clas Svahn

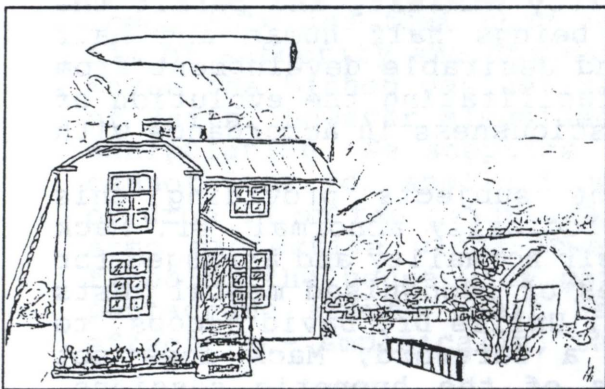
UFO sightings in broad daylight involving several witnesses are not common. However, such an incident took place at Håknäs, 40 km south of Umeå in the north of Sweden, in the autumn of 1991. As long as the investigation is in process, the witnesses must remain anonymous. This is one of many cases where representatives of the Swedish security police (SÄ-PO) have been ordered, by the military forces, to investigate a UFO sighting.

It was shortly after 1900 hrs on August 25, 1991. A married couple had just settled down in front of the TV set to watch the local news. It was still almost two hours before sunset and the sky was blue with a few clouds on the horizon.

Shortly thereafter, their daughter arrived from Umeå. She drove up to the house, turned the engine off and got out of the car.

This is her description of what followed:

- As I got out of the car, I heard the dull sound of an engine from above. I looked up and saw an object above the red house in the yard. It moved slowly across the sky. It was cylindrical and white. It had a pointed front and it was blunt at the end. It looked like a piece of piping.



- First I thought it was an aeroplane, but it had no windows or wings, nothing. I ran up the steps to the front door and called out to my mother and father to come outside and look.

Her parents hurried out and all three of them could see the strange object moving across the blue evening sky.

- Yes, it is almost unbelievable, says her father. In fact, in my opinion an object like that shouldn't be able to fly. I saw no wings or fins and no opening, just a tube.

- We watched it for quite a while, perhaps for 30 seconds. I had the time to run back into the house to search for a pair of binoculars, which I didn't find, and back out again, before it disappeared.

The three astonished witnesses watched the object slowly moving in a northwesterly direction and disappearing into a small cloud on the horizon. By then it was at such a distance that no engine sound could be heard.

A piece of white piping

When I ask the daughter to estimate the size of the object, she says that it was considerably larger than a hand on an outstretched arm. It was so big that it would have been impossible to cover it with her hand if she had held her arm up.

- The object was white, like a white car, but dark at the rear. There was no shine there (in the back), while on the main body you could see the sun shining, says the daughter.

Her father, who made a note of his observation the following day, is also certain that the sun shone on the object.

- When I came out, we could only see it from behind, he says, but there was no exhaust or lights. After a while it disappeared into a thin cloud on the horizon.

- I assumed that it was a missile, but I may have misjudged the altitude and the size. The moment I saw it I thought: It's as big as an aeroplane. Once a thought is stuck in your mind, I suppose you adjust your eyes to make the object fit into that category.

- But you never had any doubt that the object was not an aeroplane?

- No, the sun shone on its side, so I could see it glistening. It couldn't have travelled very fast. I saw it quite clearly. Then it entered a cloud. It wasn't particularly cloudy, but there were a few scattered clouds. I saw it gradually entering the cloud and disappear.

No exhaust

- Did you see any exhaust?

- No, no. I didn't see anything dark at the rear, but my daughter saw that it was dark there, and she also noticed that the front was shaped like a cone. I didn't see that, because by the time I caught sight of it, it had moved too far away.

A Forest Row woman still can not believe her eyes after sighting what she can only describe as a UFO. Last Thursday evening just after midnight Mrs. Penny Crowder was leaving Ursula and Tom Scratchly's house in Post Horn Lane, Forest Row. Before getting into her car Mrs. Crowder looked up at the clear night sky and saw a glowing orange ball with a pale orange aura surrounding it move across the sky from west over the Royal Ashdown golf course. Thinking she might be imagining things she called out to her friend Penny and they walked up the lane to get a better view. The two women were so astounded that they asked Penny's husband Tom to confirm what they were seeing.

"It was a fiery colour and looked as though it was lit up in some way," said Mrs. Crowder. "We were just incredulous, you couldn't relate it to anything because you had never seen anything like it," she said.

The three stood watching the UFO for about ten minutes as it progressed noiselessly to the east and out of sight.

Looking for a rational explanation for what they had witnessed, they telephoned flight control at Gatwick. Gatwick said nothing had showed up on radar but asked them to file a detailed description and a diagram.

They considered all the other possibilities, a hot air balloon, a satellite, but none of these fitted the description of what they had seen. They sat and talked until three in the morning about the strange fiery object.

"It gave you an eery feeling as it came straight towards you" said Mrs. Crowder, who has never before spent time puzzling over the arguments for and against the existence of UFOs. "When you started thinking about it you got a bit frightened," she said, "I had the spooks all a the way home."

Mrs. Crowder is not the first to be "spooked" by ball-shaped objects flying over the Ashdown Forest. In the late 1970s a spate of sightings over the forest exactly match the description of what Mrs. Crowder and the Scratchlys saw last Thursday evening.

In April 1978 local police launched a search of the area after a Nutley woman saw what she called a "ball of fire" hurtle past her window. She then saw bits break off the object and fall directly on to the Forest. At least six people in the Forest witnessed it, and on that night firemen were called to put out fires in two areas of the forest.
