


DISCLOSURE

SIGAP members will doubtless be familiar with CSETI (Center for the Study of Extraterrestrial Intelligence) and its director Dr Steven Greer MD, who set it up in 1991 with the intention of forcing the government of the USA to admit the presence here on earth of alien visitors, all of whom he believes, on no particular evidence, to be essentially benevolent. His method of achieving this laudable aim is the public presentation by credible witnesses of statements which they offer to present on oath to the congress of the USA.

At the National Press Club in Washington the first twenty of Dr Greer's four hundred potential jurors presented their evidence on May 9th this year. As seen on videotape, their evidence described the aerial and undersea operations of alien craft, the official suppression of such evidence and other matters very familiar to ufologists. They were mainly drawn from the middle and lower ranks of the military and intelligence communities, and there seemed no reason to impugn the integrity of any of them. It was a noble and well organised effort - and of course completely futile.

The small group at the heart of the military- industrial complex which governs the USA does not care whether its citizens believe in UFOs or not and will not be forced into any admissions on the subject. It will reveal nothing unless and until it wishes to do so. And maybe that's just as well.

SITCHIN IS NO FRAUD

Pat Thomas recently sent me a reference about an interesting archeo-astronomy research paper by J. N. Harris. It proposes that the Star of Bethlehem was Uranus, as a visible naked-eye object, which didn't strike me as very likely (and still doesn't, although the reference to Uranus as a naked-eye object does have an amusing 'ring' to it!)(2). But upon reading the paper I realised why Pat had recommended it. It contains two independent Babylonian references to Marduk-Nibiru that clearly corroborate Sitchin (3), and provide further evidence to substantiate my claims in the Dark Star Theory (4).

One of the lines of attack used by Sitchin's critics to dismiss his work is that the Sumerian and Babylonian texts simply did not refer to the solar system and its planets. They regard him as a fraud for interpreting the myths in this way. From their point of view, the stories alluded to by the early Mesopotamians were simply primitive myths about primitive gods and goddesses, and that's where the matter ends. Talk of the 12th Planet and the Annunaki is seen as dangerous nonsense.

Now, it is well known that the Babylonian knowledge of astronomy was well advanced for its time. Harris cites Babylonian quotations about their god Marduk, and highlights their crystal-clear understanding of 'his' astronomical identity. The first is from a Babylonian astrolabe:

"The red star, which when the stars of the night are finished, bisects the heavens and stands there whence the south wind comes, this star is the god Nibiru-Marduk" (5)

One might assume that this reference was to a planet of red colour, which would have to be Mars. But Marduk is in no way connected with Mars, and Harris's rather bizarre assumption that Nibiru/Marduk is Jupiter is laughable, at least on face value (Harris does indicate that Nibiru/Marduk might be a 'Jupiter-related phenomenon', but does not expand on this). Jupiter appears as a white planet, not a red one. Once again, Marduk is not correspondent with Jupiter in any of the myths, either. Instead, we have an anomalous red star that moves through the heavens in an unusual way. The reference is to an early morning celestial event, when the Sun would be rising in the east. Yet, Nibiru/Marduk is 'bisecting the heavens and standing whence the south wind comes'. It thus appears to be off the ecliptic, and low in the southern celestial hemisphere, just as I have indicated for the brown dwarf's perihelion in the planetary solar system. Brown dwarfs, as recent photos from the Hubble Space Telescope

indicate, appear red. Irrespective of my own views, what is entirely clear is that the Babylonian astronomers equated Marduk/Nibiru with an anomalous celestial phenomenon.

But then the plot thickens. The Babylonians included a similar reference in a star-list called the "12 stars of Elam, Akkad and Amurru". Whilst one recognises the importance Sitchin places upon the 12 'planets', this is a star-list, seemingly differentiating Nibiru/Marduk from the known planets:

"When the stars of Enlil have disappeared the great faint star, which bisects the heavens and stands, is Marduk-Nibiru SAG.ME.GAR; he (the god) changes his position and wanders over the heavens." (5)

One must ask oneself what the Babylonians were referring to when describing a 'great faint star'. This appears to be a contradiction in terms, until one understands the orbital properties of Nibiru. This 'planet', or brown dwarf as I have proposed, cannot be seen for the vast majority of its long motion around the Sun. Yet it is the 'Lord' of the ancient world in Mesopotamia, the very source of their gods. Its greatness was praised over all other cosmic objects, including the Sun. In this context, the quote readily makes sense.

Given these quotes from the ancient texts, it is difficult to see how Sitchin could conceivably be labelled as a fraud. His interpretation may be radical and controversial, but he is evidently presenting the facts of the matter, at least how the ancient Babylonians saw things, anyway. As they proclaimed, "This star is the god Nibiru-Marduk". And they should know...

ARE YOU READY FOR THE REVOLUTION?

"This is where I felt I had to go, and we'll see what happens."

Just over 25 years ago, American forces left Vietnam for the last time. Part of the reason for the withdrawal was the advancing North Vietnamese forces advancing on the South Vietnamese capital. The main reason for the withdrawal, however, was that the American people had turned on the idea of the war, and wanted it ended. Demonstrations in the streets of America, and acts of civil disobedience, had made the idea of continuing the war intolerable.

In a country that believes it is "Government of the people, by the people," it now appears that some people have begun to rise up on the UFO issue. These people believe that like the Vietnam War it is not a strong scientific or logical argument that will turn the tide. They believe that, like Vietnam, the issue is political in nature and political pressure is the main weapon for turning the tide. One such woman who has taken a stand on the UFO issue is a 35-year-old woman from Oakland California.

The story began on July 22, 2001, when Dr. Steven Greer arrived in San Francisco to make a presentation of his travelling Disclosure Project. The event was held at the huge Masonic Auditorium. Among the 2,000 people in the audience was a woman by the name of Lara Johnstone.

Lara was a bit skeptical of the whole extraterrestrial thing. She had no background in ufology. She had never had a sighting. A friend sent her an e-mail about the local Disclosure Event. Lara visited the Disclosure web site on the Internet. After reading the objective she decided to attend. "I never before really 'believed'" Lara wrote to President George Bush, "in 'verifiable evidence' of extraterrestrial visits." The Disclosure event turned out to be a "reality check" for Lara.

During the event the two hour Disclosure Testimony Tape was shown. This tape produced by the Disclosure project [www.disclosureproject.org] was highlights of over 100 hours of testimony that had been collected from interviews with dozens of U.S. Government, industrial, and military witnesses to UFO and extraterrestrial events and secret 'black-ops' projects. Following the presentation of the video-tape there was a presentation by Disclosure director Dr. Steven M. Greer and local San Francisco Project witnesses Carol Rosin (spokesperson for Dr. Werner Von Braun) and Daniel Sheehan (legal counsel for the Disclosure Project).

The Disclosure Testimony video was a collection of testimony clips from military and government people talking about the reality of the UFO situation. It was made up of two hours of the 100+ hours of testimony with key witnesses that the Disclosure Project had on file. The testimony that Lara witnessed that evening was more than she could take. She purchased the Disclosure book that Greer was selling at the event, which gave testimony from yet more witnesses telling the true story of what had happened regarding UFOs since 1947.

Lara decided action was necessary. She chose a form of protest that she was familiar with - a hunger strike. In late 2000 Lara had used this protest method successfully against the state of California. In an e-mail to Charles Huffer, Lara described her first hunger strike protest.

I went on a hunger strike against the CA Department of Corrections and Gov. Gray Davis. After 25 days, they bowed, admitted -- in writing -- what I had alleged, and what they had 'said', but not in writing. Before the press conference, the dept head of all of CA's prisons came up to me and went ballistic. He started screaming 'Who do you think you are!' 'How dare you!' and on and on! He did not like being called up by the South African media, asked to answer very difficult questions regarding how he runs his prisons!

Following the disclosure event, Lara quickly researched the UFO subject in preparation for sending a letter to President Bush on the subject. As a part of this effort she contacted Charles Huffer, an Arkansas UFO researcher, who on July 28, 2000, had the opportunity to question President elect Bush while he was on the campaign trail for President. During this encounter Huffer asked Bush "Half the public believes that UFOs are real." Would you finally tell us what the hell is going on? " Bush replied, "Sure I will."

A few minutes later Huffer ran into Bush again and the president-elect stated, " It will be the first thing that he will do." (He pointed at Dick Cheney who was just walking up) "He'll get right on it."

Lara used the Huffer encounter with Bush to time the beginning of her hunger strike. The hunger strike would begin exactly one year to the day Bush promised he would work to tell the people about UFOs. She wrote in her July 26, 2001 letter of protest to President Bush.

One year later, on 28 July 2001, you are now the President and I again ask you "Are you willing to finally tell the American people and the whole world, the truth about unidentified flying objects?" Hundreds of high-level US government officials are standing courageous and willing to tell the truth, which can change our world. Will you give them the opportunity? Can we begin healing our world? Can we end this endeavour of greed, corruption, fear and destruction? Can we find a way to take a stand, step by step? If we continue this way, we'll only end up where we are going. It doesn't have to be this way. We have a choice.

As a South African, Lara Johnstone also addressed her letter of protest to President Thabo Mbeki of South Africa, as well as President George Bush. She outlined her request,

President Bush and President Mbeki, I am writing to share with you and all the other leaders around the world my extreme concern. My concern is so great, that I have decided to go on a hunger strike, starting July 28, 2001, to death if need be, in order to express my humble request. My request is that the U.S. and other governments: 1. Hold open, comprehensive, secrecy-free hearings to take military/agency witness testimony on events and evidence relating to an Extraterrestrial presence on and around Earth. 2. To hold open hearings on advanced energy and propulsion systems, relating to extraterrestrial phenomena that, when publicly released, will provide solutions to global environmental challenges. 3. To enact legislation, which will ban all space-based weapons, and to enact and implement international treaties and legal standards prohibiting the weaponisation of space. 4. To enact comprehensive legislation to research, develop and explore space peacefully and co-operatively with all cultures on Earth and in space.

In an interview with Lara Johnstone, I asked her about her plans for the hunger strike. She stated, "I'm on my way to D.C. I was going to do a bus trip across the country. I am hoping to be in Washington by the 28th of August, which would make the hunger strike at one month, but I'm flexible on that. I have this feeling that I must not plan too much - that things are going to work right. Things are going to happen, and I should just be open and trusting. It started on the 28th of July to August 28th will be a month, and then interestingly enough the 28th of September will be two months and that is the start of the anti-globalisation demonstrations."

Lara has received the expected reactions from people to her hunger strike. Some have said that she is "totally nuts." One person told her, "You don't want to just take on the whole world - now you want to save the aliens too." To this Lara responded, "I said it's not about that. It's about all of us knowing what's going on. Are we just here to buy buy buy being little consumers, or are we here for a bigger purpose? To grow and to love. For me it's about the truth. With the secrecy we're spreading more fear, and more fear, and it's separation."

Lara is preparing a web site where people can access the letters she has sent out, and stay updated on what responses she has received. She is preparing a letter for all members of Congress, and is sending out letters to names she received of people inside the UFO community who might be able to help her.

Robert H. Williams, a man who lost his job at Clinton Community College in Plattsburgh, New York, for his UFO beliefs, has been kind enough to help Lara in her time of need. On his personal web site, Robert is hosting a section with copies of all the initial correspondence between Lara and Charles Huffer, and the letter to the President. To view this

VATICAN THEOLOGIAN CLAIMS EXTRATERRESTRIAL CONTACT IS REAL

ROME – Monsignor Corrado Balducci, an insider close to the Pope has gone on national Italian television five times in recent months to proclaim: Extraterrestrial contact is a real phenomenon. The prelate announced that the Vatican is receiving much information about extraterrestrials and their contacts with humans from its Nuncios (embassies) in various countries, such as Mexico, Chile and Venezuela. Monsignor Balducci said that he is on a Vatican commission looking into extraterrestrial encounters, and how to cope with the emerging general realisation of extraterrestrial contact. Balducci provided the Roman Catholic Church's analysis of extraterrestrials, emphasising that these encounters "are NOT demonic, they are NOT due to psychological impairment, they are NOT a case of entity attachment, but these encounters deserve to be studied carefully." CHUPACABRAS FOUND AND FILMED IN NICARAGUA?

Specialists described the animal as an uncommon species after a careful examination of its skeleton. It presents yellow hair on its short tail, large eye-sockets, soft skin like that of a bat, large claws and fangs, and a crest on its main vertebrae.



Could this be the Chupacabras? A team of biologists and veterinarians from Leon must now answer the question. The skeleton of the animal that quenched its thirst with the blood of sheep on the San Lorenzo farm, owned by Jorge Luis Talavera and located at Km. 154 of Malpaisillo, Nicaragua, was found in the early morning hours of Monday (28/8/2000) some 80 metres away from the paddock where it procured its victims.


"The creature could be a hybrid of several species, created in a laboratory by means of genetic engineering," noted Gioconda Chevez, Malpaisillo's veterinarian. Jorge Talavera explained that three days ago he opened fire against the alleged Chupacabras using a shotgun, causing its death and resulting in its flesh being devoured by vultures. The creature was in an advanced state of decomposition by the time it was discovered.

"We had to kill it. In 15 days it sucked 25 sheep, and my neighbour lost 35 sheep in 10 days. It was an average of 5 sheep and goats a night," he explained. Captain Leonardo Carmona, head of the Malpaisillo Crime Lab, indicated that the animal's remains are to be studied at the Hospital Escuela de Leon (Leon Teaching Hospital), where veterinarians and biologists shall be on hand to examine it, according to a report by Edgard Orozco, who is in charge of the Department of Forensic Medicine.

The skeleton of the suspected Chupacabras was taken to the Medical Campus of UNAN-Leon yesterday, to determine the species to that it belongs, affirmed the biologist Pedrarias Dávila. We recorded the characteristics of the skeletal system, number of vertebrae and ribs, nails, decomposition state, among others, to place it in a database, he explained.

He added that the second stage (of the analysis) includes/understands the preservation of the rest so that the state of decomposition does not advance; and third, a team of specialists will establish to what species the animal belongs. Dávila showed that they do not relate it to any well-known animal because they could hurry.

What is assured is that the remains belonged to 'heterodonto,' that is to say a mammal. "We can not say when there will be results because we lack some pieces (of the animal), that is the reason why we must take time; for example, if we must send samples of DNA to the outside for analysis," said Dávila. Jorge Luis Talavera, owner of the property San Lorenzo, where the supposed Chupacabras shot and killed, said, "There were three targets...and one was black. The one that died was yellow. "In previous weeks, I wounded one, but I did not manage to kill it," he concluded. The animal's skeleton that sucked the blood of the sheep at the farm "San Lorenzo", property of Jorge Luis Talavera, 154 kilometres of Malpasillo, was found in the early Monday morning hours 80 metres from the victim's corral. "It could be a hybrid animal made up of several species, created in a laboratory by genetic engineering", said Gioconda Chévez, veterinarian of Malpasillo. The Specialist described the animal as a very uncommon species, after observing the skeleton with yellow hair on its short tail, having great eye cavities, smooth bat-like skin, big claws, a jaw showing big teeth and an outstanding crest sticking out from the main vertebra.



Captain Leonardo Carmona, Laboratory Criminalist Chief of Malpasillo, said that the remains of the animal will be studied in the Hospital School of León, where veterinarians and biologists will assist in the examination of the remains, according to the information provided by Edgard Orozco, responsible for the Department of Pathology.

WHY 1947?

The modern UFO wave began in 1947, with a tremendous amount of activity observed over sensitive industrial and military sites. It is clear from the reports that come out of that era, that this was the aspect of the UFO phenomenon that initially raised concerns within the military establishment. After all, if your most sensitive atomic research and weapons storage facilities are being buzzed by craft of unknown origin with impunity, then alarm bells will ring. This specific targeting by the UFO occupants clearly showed their interest in this aspect of our development.

In his book "Flying Saucers from Outer Space", Major Donald Keyhoe cites a US Air Force document released on 30th December 1949:

"Since the acts of mankind most easily observed from a distance are A-bomb explosions, we should expect some relation to obtain (sic) between the time of the A-bomb explosions, the time at which the space ships are seen, and the time required for such ships to arrive from and return to home base".

This line of reasoning leads to an unexpected conclusion. Even if one assumes that the visitors have somehow discovered a means to defeat the universal limit of the speed of light, information travelling from our planet was travelling at that very velocity. By that measure, the earliest date that information about the Hiroshima explosion could arrive at the nearest neighbouring star is 1949. Yet the first big UFO wave occurred in the summer of 1947, less than 2 years after Hiroshima. This would seem to preclude interstellar visitors. However, Project Sign inferred a greater likelihood that the visitors came from outside our Solar System:

"Thus, the chance of space travellers existing on planets attached to neighbouring stars is very much greater than the chance of space-travelling Martians".

Certainly, our subsequent exploration of the Solar System would seem to bear this out. Some of the other planets and moons could certainly be used as a base for ET exploration and operations, but none has the conditions available for evolution of life and development of intelligent species. Yet the UFOs turn up in half the time it takes for light leaving Earth to arrive at Alpha Centauri.

Let us assume, then, that travel faster than the speed of light is impossible, as proven by Einstein. Let us also assume that life in an indigenous form does not exist on any of the Sun's other planets or moons. Then two possibilities present themselves:

1) The alien presence has an outpost in the Solar System big enough to supply the UFO flaps of 1947 and 1952 (1954 would be the earliest a contingent from Alpha Centauri could arrive).

2) The alien home world is between us and the nearest star, at a maximum distance of 1 light year.

Foo fighter activity during the Second World War implies that we were being monitored in the early Forties, and these were clearly unmanned probes of some kind. It is likely that these came from somewhere close to home, implying a base on Earth or maybe the Moon. After all, no sightings of "motherships" or craft large enough to hold beings were reported. It was generally assumed that the foo fighters were a secret Axis weapon.

Yet, 1947 saw the arrival of an entirely different phenomenon of sizeable vehicles interested in atomic sites. Given the alleged veracity of the Roswell case, the saucer occupants were not entirely prepared for our defences, losing a craft within just one week of the first sighting of their activity. This implies that this was their first excursion into hostile terrain. A lot of sabre-rattling by both the UFOs and US military is evident in the reports over the next few years, with the loss of at least one jet during these mock dogfights.

The point is this; why weren't the manned vehicles in our skies during the war? We were clearly being monitored at that time, presumably from an unmanned base close to home (either on the Moon or even Earth itself). If a manned outpost existed in the Solar System of the sort of proportions to send the 1947 and 1952 waves, they would have been putting saucers in our skies long before then. Following this logic, it seems unlikely that the first of the possibilities above is the case. The saucers are not based in the Solar System. Which leaves the second. Which is impossible, right? How could a home world exist in the outer reaches of the Solar System's influence?

Well, what if the home-world orbits a star so dim and insignificant that it has eluded us, even though it is right on our door-step? Could a brown dwarf orbiting the Sun create conditions on an orbiting moon ripe for the evolution of life and intelligent beings? Since such a brown dwarf is now known to exist about 2 trillion miles from the Sun, then perhaps this possibility needs to be looked at seriously by Ufologists.

ET BASE ON EARTH SANCTIONED BY OFFICIALS SINCE 1954 CONFIRMED

In July of 1952 the world was electrified by large newspaper headlines and photos of squadrons of UFOs flying repeatedly over the nation's Capital in Washington, DC. Four months later WW II General Dwight Eisenhower was elected President.

The same month President Eisenhower took office (January 1953), the CIA's Office of Scientific Intelligence (OSI) was ordered to determine if UFOs were interstellar vehicles. OSI convened the Robertson Panel of scientists, which recommended that the Air Force study of UFOs, Project Blue Book, be expanded.

A year later, in April, 1954, as documented by Gerald Light, President Eisenhower made a secret trip to Muroc Field (now Edwards Air Force Base), in the California desert, accompanied by generals, reporter Franklin Allen of the Hearst News papers Group, Los Angeles Catholic Bishop James McIntyre, and others. The President had previously arranged to be in nearby Palm Springs, CA, purportedly for a golfing vacation. He "was spirited over to Muroc one night," while reporters were fed the cover story that the President had a toothache and needed to see a dentist.

While at Muroc Air Field, Eisenhower was present while an extraterrestrial disc landed. Several Star Visitors emerged to converse with the President and the generals. The extraterrestrials requested that Eisenhower make the public aware of extraterrestrial contact with Earth forthwith. The President protested that humans were not ready, and needed time to be prepared for adjusting to this stupendous reality.

By the end of the following month, May, 1954, President Eisenhower's CIA Director, Walter Bedell Smith, Prince Bernhard of Netherlands, David Rockefeller and other top world financiers, later Secretary of State Dean Rusk, later British Minister of Defence Denis Healey, and other Western power leaders convened the inaugural meeting of the Bilderberg Group, "a means of Western collective management of the world order". (Sklar, H., ed., 1981. Trilateralism. Boston: South End Press.) One of the early items on the agenda of this world management policy board was extraterrestrial contact.

The following information was disclosed to me by a confidential reliable informant, who previously worked on contract for the National Security Agency, and maintains connections within the Intelligence community. This information has been confirmed by a second source, Dr. Michael Wolf of the National Security Council's unacknowledged subcommittee, the MJ-12 Special Studies Group. The report which

follows is not "leaks". The release of this information is part of the Acclimation Program, an official though unacknowledged U.S. Government policy of "processed release of information", as Dr. Wolf describes it. (Any information presented in this report which I have developed independent of these two governmental informants will appear in parentheses.)

Shortly after establishing itself, the Bilderberg Group collaborated with the Council on Foreign Relations (CFR), another international policy body devoted to world management, concerning the problem of adjusting humankind to extraterrestrial presence. Bilderberg and CFR decided jointly in the mid-1950s to enter into an arrangement with the extraterrestrials: The ETs were given an island in French Polynesia as a base on Earth. This arrangement afforded them an opportunity to monitor closely Earth cultures and behaviour; and it permitted Earth governments a way to monitor extraterrestrial culture and behaviour. "It became an on-going experiment," as my former-NSA informant put it. He adds that when official public announcement of the extraterrestrial presence occurs, "they will be the ones introduced to Earthlings; 'Oh, by the way, we want to welcome our neighbours from the Pleiades, who by the way have been here since [the beginning of Earth] time, but [are] actually living in our place, date, space and time.'" The informant adds, "They are the diplomatic corps."

My ex-NSA informant reported that the U.S. particularly held out for many concessions before agreeing to the arrangement. (He did not specify what those concessions were, but history subsequent to 1954 suggests that what the U.S. obtained was the lion's share of extraterrestrial scientist consultants, to assist American scientists in understanding and adapting exotic ET technologies into such devices we now know as the computer chip, fibre optics, lasers, gene-splicing therapy, cloning, night-vision equipment, super-tenacity fibres (such as Kevlar lightweight armour), aerospace ceramics, Stealth technology, particle-beam devices, and gravity-control flight.) NSC's Dr. Michael Wolf has previously revealed in his book *The Catchers of Heaven* that he worked with ETs as part of his governmental duties. "I met with extraterrestrial individuals every day in my work, and shared living quarters with them," while doing research at extremely classified underground government research laboratories. He added, "Zetas work in underground facilities, as requested by the U.S. Government. The ETs are not breaking the U.S. Government- Zeta treaties, but the Government has broken treaties by mistreating ETs, and trying to fire on UFOs." Dr. Wolf also described working with very human-appearing races dubbed the Nordics and Semitics. He said, "The Semitics and Nordics come from Altair 4 and 5 and from the Pleiades [star systems]."


Wolf also disclosed that in 1954 the U.S. had four extraterrestrial corpses in the "Blue Room", Hanger 18 at Wright-Patterson Air Force

Base, Dayton, Ohio. These bodies came from a series of retrievals of downed UFOs. "The first UFO came down in 1941 into the ocean west of San Diego, and was retrieved by the Navy." (The Navy has held a leadership position in UFO matters ever since.) Between that and the first publicly-announced UFO crash in 1947, northwest of Roswell, New Mexico, Wolf says there was another crash in 1946, as well as two other crashes in 1947 besides Roswell.

DISCLOSURE PROJECT: Witness Summary Attachment

The following is a brief summary list of some of the top-secret witnesses identified by Dr. Greer who are willing to be interviewed in the Disclosure Project investigative news special and related projects. Approximately 200 such military and government witnesses to UFO/ETI events currently exist.

Witness A: Captain of a navy contract vessel in charge of retrieving ICBM test missiles in the south Atlantic, August 1963. During one evening, UFO seen on radar and then abruptly disappeared. Following morning, the captain was vectored to the place where the UFO vanished and they found an ejection pod, approximately 6 feet by 6 feet, containing 3 extraterrestrial biological entities (EBEs): Each ET was clad in a one piece flight suit, was about 40 inches tall, olive complexion, 4 digits, etc. This witness handled the EBEs and has detailed information concerning their morphology, how they were taken off of his ship by a navy nuclear submarine and how the ET ejection pod was transferred to another surface ship.

Witness B: Merle Shane McDow; a naval worker at Atlantic Command, Norfolk, with a top-secret, SCI (Special Compartmentalised Intelligence) clearance, October 1981. Present during a prolonged encounter off the eastern US seaboard of a 300-foot UFO, disc shaped, which came in from space, and was monitored on radar (multiple) and KH-11 spy satellites. This witness was in the control room at Atlantic Command during the entire event. The UFO was confirmed (by hotline) to be neither Soviet nor US. Admiral X (known to us) then gave the order to force down or destroy the object, and military jets were scrambled from land and sea-based carriers in the Atlantic. The UFO propulsion was so extraordinary that in ONE sweep of the radar screen, the disc would move from off the coast of Newfoundland, to the area of Jacksonville Florida. One jet briefly got close enough to photograph the object (clear conditions, unlimited visibility). This photograph was later enlarged and shown on large screen in the Atlantic Command for Admiral X. This witness was present throughout the encounter and chase, and subsequently saw the photograph of the huge metallic disc.

Witness C: Major George Filer, Air Force Intelligence (21st Air Force Intel) at McGuire Air Force Base NJ, November 1978, came in to work one morning and found the control room in chaos. He was informed that a UFO had violated the perimeter of the base the previous night, and that an ET was shot and killed outside on the tarmac. He was informed that he was to brief the general of the base that morning. Major Filer collected information on the event

and prepared to brief the general, but subsequently 'Blue Berets' from Wright-Patterson AFB in Dayton Ohio flew in and took over the operation. An Air Force C-141 transport came and took the ET body (deceased) to Wright-Patterson AFB.

Witness D: is an MP who guarded the ET body prior to disposition and stood near the body (Witness D is NOT known to Witness C).

Witness E: Edwards Air Force Base Air Traffic Controller, present during long and detailed encounter with up to 7 UFOs over the Edwards facility in 1965. Controller had UFOs on radar for over FOUR HOURS and had jets scrambled to pursue. Each time 'lock on' occurred with on-board jet radar, the UFOs would disappear and instantly reappear in another area of the sky. Also noted landing event of UFO at one point. We have located and possess the previously scrambled tape recording of the air traffic control conversations with jet pilots and others about the encounter. The tape recording corroborates the account of this important witness.

Witness F: Soviet Cosmonaut PP, most decorated Soviet cosmonaut, has had multiple UFO encounters and sightings as both a pilot and cosmonaut. He is willing to describe these in detail.

Witness G: Sandia National Laboratories Engineer who directly worked with and knew of programs studying extraterrestrial materials and technologies for reverse-engineering tasks. This witness also has knowledge of security surrounding such ET technology transfer projects and specifics of types of devices studied with applications.

Witness H: Captain GB, a navy pilot and captain who in 1951 was flying a group of Navy VIPs across the north Atlantic when he and his co-pilot saw what looked like a small city in the middle of the ocean. They contacted Gander radar which confirmed the object on radar. The UFO moved in 1-2 seconds from a distance of 25 miles to directly in front of the plane. Auto-pilot was disengaged to avoid a collision. Object flew along beside them and then took off at extraordinary speed and was out of range very quickly. Substantial electromagnetic effects from the craft occurred, including gyroscope spinning wildly out of control when the UFO was very near. Estimated size about 300 feet diameter. Corroborating official government documents and report of the events have been obtained by the pilot and are now in our possession.

Witness I and Witness J: Two separate witnesses, unknown to each other, who at different times and at different places, saw NASA photographs with UFO or ET facilities (moon). Witness I was present at Johnson Space Center, working under contract with Ford Aerospace, and directly saw clear day time photograph

from a satellite with a disc shaped UFO, which cast a shadow on the earth beneath it. When she asked what they would do with the photo (she wrongly assumed it would be released to the public) she was told that it, like others, would be altered and the UFO would be removed from the image prior to release to non-secure NASA or other agency use. Witness I saw strips of film showing extensive artificial structures on the dark side of the moon which were there as a result of the Lunar Orbiter overflights.

Witness K: Major SL, a respected lawyer, was an Army cryptographer in the Pentagon 1959-61. He was shown metal samples of debris from the crash of an extraterrestrial craft in New Mexico in the late 1940s, and it was demonstrated to him the extraordinary properties of the material. He saw the ET writing on the debris and was told it was being studied by Army cryptographers, but that they had not (in 1959) broken the code. He also had confirmed to him then President Eisenhower's interest in the subject, that he knew of the subject, but that he was being left out of substantial information dealing with ET technology programs. Major SL had a top-secret clearance and continues to possess a top-secret clearance as an Army reserve Major.

Witness L: Counter-Intelligence Corp (CIC) officer from the 1940s who was directly at the site of a crashed extraterrestrial device and who directly saw the device and the EBEs which had died at the site of the event.

Witness M: DD, Air Force Office of Special Investigations, very decorated officer with detailed knowledge of recent covert programs related to the subject of UFOs and who has been in an underground storage facility at Fort Huachuca AZ (Army Intelligence Headquarters) where he has personally seen multiple retrieved extraterrestrial craft and ET bodies in storage. He has knowledge of the nature of the ultra-secret group which manages the UFO matter. Witness M is a very credible witness who is seriously afraid of being identified and whose identity will need to remain secret (disguised).

Witness N: Lt. Col. John Williams, a highly respected Air Force officer and public relations official, present at NE air force base in 1969 during a prolonged encounter with large, silent triangular UFOs which over-flew area of base with strategic nuclear assets. Was on base radar and seen by others in the area. As public information officer, has knowledge of how such events were/are denied, covered up and 'spun'.

Witness O: Cosmonaut MP, USSR, highly decorated test pilot and cosmonaut with multiple unmistakable sightings and encounters while working as a test pilot and cosmonaut.

Witness P: Air Force Colonel Phillip J. Corso, involved with covert programs related to retrieval and study of crashed ET craft, including extensive knowledge of applications of reverse-engineered extraterrestrial technologies and covert management and disinformation on the subject. Also had assignments with the National Security Council and other intelligence and military programs, and has impeccable credentials.

Witness Q: KS, US Air Force career air traffic controller and radar operator with top secret clearance, present at Minot ND Strategic Air Command (ICBM) base who had multiple extraordinary encounters with UFOs on radar and documented manoeuvrability of shocking proportions such as instant vertical accelerations to >5000 miles per hour straight up, against the force of gravity, etc.

Witness R: Mercury Astronaut and American hero Gordon Cooper, had clear sighting of disc shaped UFO 1950s and also had his squadron film a landed UFO at Edwards Air Force Base. Film was flown on the general's plane to the Pentagon and was never seen again.

Witness S: Admiral Lord Hill Norton (five star admiral) and former head of British Ministry of Defence (MOD) and MI-5, MI-6, is an inverse witness. That is, he is willing to go on record that he knows the subject is real but that as MOD head he was kept in the dark about projects related to the subject, even though he knows now that they were on-going during his term in office. This inverse witness provides extraordinary insight into the depth of secrecy surrounding the subject. As one of the most decorated military officers of the 20th century, his insights are historic and compelling and expose the unprecedented level of secrecy related to this subject.

Witness T: Michael Smith, USAF Radar operator and air traffic control officer present during multiple UFO craft overflights at the Klamath Falls OR Keno site in 1972; confirms that NORAD at Cheyenne Mountain CO would 'hand-off' the UFOs routinely and provide a 'heads up' warning that they were coming, and ask that military traffic be routed around the path of the speeding UFOs. Also later present at a very low altitude event, on radar, in Ohio, which resulted in police car chase of the UFO through the countryside.

NOTE: There are multiple additional witnesses equal to those listed above, but we have listed these as they represent various military and intelligence operations over a wide span of time and place. All witnesses are willing to sign statements that their information is truthful and that they would be willing to testify under oath before Congress regarding these events and programs.

07/08/01-HUNDREDS WATCH UFO DOGFIGHT OVER RUSSIAN AIRBASE!

Serov, Russia - Hundreds of awestruck eyewitnesses reportedly watched in shock and disbelief as at least 36 UFOs waged a spectacular dogfight above a Russian air base! The incredible aerial battle, which took place at an altitude of about 5,200 feet, was seen by witnesses not prone to hysteria or exaggeration, including members of the Russian air force, military intelligence officers and two visiting foreign journalists, from Poland and Latvia. "For approximately 12 minutes, the sky was ablaze with death rays fired from the battling starships," says Polish news reporter Igor Wroclawski, who was there to cover an air show scheduled for the next day. "Several of the craft that were hit appeared to be damaged by the rays and one of them caught fire and crashed into the mountains." The dogfight erupted at 2:05 a.m. on May 11 at an air base near Serov, at the foothills of the Ural Mountains, according to Wroclawski. Radar first detected two groups of massive objects entering Russian air space, one from the northeast, the other from the west, like giant schools of fish.

"The base was put on full alert," says the correspondent, who first told his story on Polish radio. "When I went outside in my pyjamas, some of the soldiers were standing there, pointing up in the sky," says Wroclawski.

"I looked up and I could see dozens of saucer-shaped objects circling overhead." The unidentified vessels appeared to be about 90 feet in diameter, he said. Within minutes of the initial radar sightings, the two sets of flying discs opened fire "The weapons were as deafening as thunder and they lit up the entire night sky," says Wroclawski. "It was terrifying to watch." After 12 minutes, one fleet of UFOs took off to the south, with the other group in hot pursuit. Wroclawski claims he snapped a photo of the air duel, but it was seized by intelligence officers.

The Russian government emphatically denies the report, claiming there have been no recent sightings of UFOs at any Russian installations. But U.S. intelligence sources aren't buying it. "If a UFO really did crash in the Ural Mountains, you can bet the Russians are going to keep it secret until they have a chance to salvage any alien technology they can," a CIA source observed.

Dr. James E. McDonald -- What Might Have Been -- 2

Following up on McDonald's testimony before Congress in 1968 is this speech before the AAAS late in 1969, in the wake of the so-called Condon report. Remember how McDonald skewered Menzel in the testimony quoted in Part 1 of this series? Well, he is just about to widen the range of his skewer -- to Hynek! My comments on elements in this speech will appear inside parentheses. []

You are about to read part of the remarks made at the ONLY public scientific look at the UFO. And a sad record it is.

No scientifically adequate investigation of the UFO problem has been carried out during the entire 22 years that have now passed since the first extensive wave of sightings of unidentified aerial objects in the summer of 1947. Despite continued public interest, and despite frequent expressions of public concern, only quite superficial examinations of the steadily growing body of unexplained UFO reports from credible witnesses have been conducted in this country or abroad. The latter point is highly relevant, since all evidence now points to the fact that UFO sightings exhibit similar characteristics throughout the world. *[This is a devastating charge, especially for Hynek, the AF's scientific consultant for many years. But we've just begun.]*

Charging inadequacy of all past UFO investigations, I speak not only from a background of close study of the past investigations, but also from a background of three years of rather detailed personal research, involving interviews with over five hundred witnesses in selected UFO cases, chiefly in the U.S. In my opinion, the UFO problem, far from being the nonsense problem that it has often been labelled by many scientists, constitutes a problem of extraordinary scientific interest.

[This is a charge of scientific incompetence, against whom?]

The grave difficulty with essentially all past UFO studies has been that they were either devoid of any substantial scientific content, or else have lost their way amidst the relatively large

noise-content that tends to obscure the real signal in the UFO reports. The presence of a percentually large number of reports of misidentified natural or technological phenomena (planets, meteors, and aircraft, above all) is not surprising, given all the circumstances surrounding the UFO problem. Yet such understandable and usually easily recognised instances of misidentification have all too often been seized upon as a sufficient explanation for all UFO reports, while the residue of far more significant reports (numbering now of order one thousand) are ignored. I believe science is in default for having failed to mount any truly adequate studies of this problem, a problem that has aroused such strong and widespread public concern during the past two decades. Unfortunately, the present climate of thinking, above all since release of the latest of a long series of inadequate studies, namely, that conducted under the direction of Dr. E.U. Condon at the University of Colorado, will make it very difficult to secure any new and more thorough investigations, yet my own examination of the problem forces me to call for just such new studies. I am enough of a realist to sense that, unless the present AAAS UFO Symposium succeeds in making the scientific community aware of the seriousness of the UFO problem, little immediate response to any call for new investigation is likely to appear.

["Devoid of any substantial content!!!!" Wow!]

In fact, the over-all public and scientific response to the UFO phenomena is itself a matter of substantial scientific interest, above all in its social-psychological aspects. Prior to my own investigations, I would never have imagined the widespread reluctance to report an unusual and seemingly inexplicable event, yet that reluctance, and the attendant reluctance of scientists to exhibit serious interest in the phenomena in question, are quite general. One regrettable result is the fact that the most credible of UFO witnesses are often those most reluctant to come forward with a report of the event they have witnessed. A second regrettable result is that only a very small number of scientists have taken the time and trouble to search out the nearly puzzling reports that tend to be diluted out by the much larger number of trivial and non-significant UFO reports. The net result is that there still exists no general scientific recognition of the scope and nature of the UFO problem.

[Now, I ask you, has anything changed today, 32 years later?]

"Within the federal government official responsibility for UFO investigations has rested with the Air Force since early 1948. Unidentified aerial objects quite naturally fall within the area of Air Force concern, so this assignment of responsibility was

basically reasonable. However, once it became clear (early 1949) that UFO reports did not seem to involve advanced aircraft of some hostile foreign power, Air Force interest subsided to relatively low levels, marked, however, by occasional temporary resurgence of interest following large waves of UFO reports, such as that of 1952, or 1957, or 1965.

"A most unfortunate pattern of press reporting developed by about 1953, in which the Air Force would assert that they had found no evidence of anything "defying explanation in terms of present-day science and technology" in their growing files of UFO reports. These statements to the public would have done little harm had they not been coupled systematically to press statements asserting that "the best scientific facilities available to the U. S. Air Force" had been and were being brought to bear on the UFO question. The assurances that substantial scientific competence was involved in Air Force UFO investigations have, I submit, had seriously deleterious scientific effects. Scientists who might otherwise have done enough checking to see that a substantial scientific puzzle lay in the UFO area were misled by these assurances into thinking that capable scientists had already done adequate study and found nothing. My own extensive checks have revealed so slight a total amount of scientific competence in two decades of Air Force-supported investigations that I can only regard the repeated asseverations of solid scientific study of the UFO problem as the single most serious obstacle that the Air Force has put in the way of progress towards elucidation of the matter."

[Not much left of Hynek and the Air Force but smoking ruins after this paragraph -- and McDonald had the goods to back up this statement, too. And he did the same for Condon!]

"I do not believe, let me stress, that this has been part of some top-secret cover-up of extensive investigations by Air Force or security agencies; I have found no substantial basis for accepting that theory of why the Air Force has so long failed to respond appropriately to the many significant and scientifically intriguing UFO reports coming from within its own ranks. Briefly, I see grand foul-up but not grand cover-up. Although numerous instances could be cited wherein Air Force spokesmen failed to release anything like complete details of UFO reports, and although this has had the regrettable consequence of denying scientists at large even a dim notion of the almost incredible nature of some of the more impressive Air Force-related UFO reports, I still feel that the most grievous fault of 22 years of Air Force handling of the UFO problem has consisted of

their repeated public assertions that they had substantial scientific competence on the job.

[You have to understand that McDonald was participating in a Navy program as he said these words, was a Naval Reserve Officer and under orders in one way or another. There was no way he was going to accuse anyone directly of a "cover-up." But, let me tell you, before he was through with Hynek and the Air Force they were probably wishing he WOULD accuse them of covering something up. As it was he was accusing them of being idiots.]

"Close examination of the level of investigation and the level of scientific analysis involved in Project Sign (1948-9), Project Grudge (1949-52), and Project Bluebook (1953 to date), reveals that these were, viewed scientifically, almost meaningless investigations. Even during occasional periods (e.g., 1952) characterised by fairly active investigation of UFO cases, there was still such slight scientific expertise involved that there was never any real chance that the puzzling phenomena encountered in the most significant UFO cases would be elucidated. Furthermore, the panels, consultants, contractual studies, etc., that the Air Force has had working on the UFO problem over the past 22 years have, with essentially no exception, brought almost negligible scientific scrutiny into the picture. Illustrative examples will be given.

[You see what he is doing! The Robertson Panel, with some of the top people in the country on it, is being SAVAGED! This guy is not shooting small fish in a small barrel - NO! He is going after Berkner, Robertson, Page and others with this - and it is DEVASTATING. The vibrations HAD to go up the line after this, no matter what the press and public understood, which wasn't much.]

"The Condon Report, released in January, 1968, after about two years of Air Force-supported study is, in my opinion, quite inadequate. The sheer bulk of the Report, and the inclusion of much that can only be viewed as "scientific padding", cannot conceal from anyone who studies it closely the salient point that it represents an examination of only a tiny fraction of the most puzzling UFO reports of the past two decades, and that its level of scientific argumentation is wholly unsatisfactory. Furthermore, of the roughly 90 cases that it specifically confronts, over 30 are conceded to be unexplained. With so large a fraction of unexplained cases (out of a sample that is by no means limited only to the truly puzzling cases, but includes an objectionably large number of obviously trivial cases), it is far from clear how Dr. Condon felt justified in concluding that the study indicated "that further extensive study of UFOs

probably cannot be justified in the expectation that science will be advanced thereby."

[Poor Condon, accused of being an idiot and anyone who reads the report will see why. Before McDonald is through with him he will need a seeing-eye dog to go to the bathroom.]

I shall cite a number of specific examples of cases from the Condon Report which I regard as entirely inadequately investigated and reported. One at Kirtland AFB, November 4, 1957, involved observations of a wingless egg-shaped object that was observed hovering about a minute over the field prior to departure at a climb rate which was described to me as faster than that of any known jets, then or now. The principal witnesses in this case were precisely the type of witnesses whose accounts warrant closest attention, since they were CAA tower observers who watched the UFO from the CAA tower with binoculars. Yet, when I located these two men in the course of my own check of cases from the Condon Report, I found that neither of them had even been contacted by members of the University of Colorado project! Both men were fully satisfied that they had been viewing a device with performance characteristics well beyond any thing in present or foreseeable aeronautical technology. The two men gave me descriptions that were mutually consistent and that fit closely the testimony given on Nov. 6, 1957, when they were interrogated by an Air Force investigator. The Condon Report attempts to explain this case as a light aircraft that lost its way, came into the field area, and then left. This kind of explanation runs through the whole Condon Report, yet is wholly incapable of explaining the details of sightings such as that of the Kirtland AFB incident. Other illustrative instances in which the investigations summarised in the Condon Report exhibit glaring deficiencies will be cited. I suggest that there are enough significant unexplainable UFO reports just within the Condon Report itself to document the need for a greatly increased level of scientific study of UFOs.

[Yes!! Yes!! Yes!! The staff submarined Condon, who never even read the report he put his name to! They managed to stack the DATA to the point where even a moron could see what was going on -- if the moron bothered to actually READ the report! But no one did and the Condon Report became one of those things that everyone talked about but nobody had read. But McDonald HAD read the thing -- to Condon's shame.]

"That a panel of the National Academy of Sciences could endorse this study is to me disturbing. I find no evidence that the Academy panel did any independent checking of its own; and none

of that 11-man panel had any significant prior investigative experience in this area, to my knowledge. I believe that this sort of Academy endorsement must be criticised; it hurts science in the long run, and I fear that this particular instance will ultimately prove an embarrassment to the National Academy of Sciences.

The Condon Report and its Academy endorsement have exerted a highly negative influence on clarification of the long-standing UFO problem; so much, in fact, that it seems almost pointless to now call for new and more extensive UFO investigations. Yet the latter are precisely what are needed to bring out into full light of scientific inquiry a phenomenon that could well constitute one of the greatest scientific problems of our times."

[This takes guts, to go before an AAAS meeting and blast THEM, too, for the same reasons you have blasted the Air Force, Hynek and Condon. You see the kind of person who was loose on the scene back then? Credible, capable, well known, operating in his area of scientific competence -- in other words: DANGEROUS to the program others were running, over and above the Air Force, Hynek and Condon. What happens in any bureaucracy when an employee begins to speak up against the boss? McDonald knew that.]

NEWS IN BRIEF/ SIGHTINGS ROUNDUP

LONDON -- Russel Callaghan writes that UFO Magazine has been presented with some amazing daylight UFO footage recorded over Lewisham, London on July 1st 2001. Whatever Christopher filmed brings back some of the dozens of reports we have seen describing 'Boomerang or Triangular' UFOs. You can watch the video at www.ufomag.co.uk.

WEST WILTSHIRE -- A UFO was spotted June 13, 2001, by two sets of witnesses over Semington and Trowbridge between 10:20 and 11:10 PM. Eyewitness Roger White saw a bright light at 11:10 PM over Semington. "It seemed to be moving slowly," he said. "At first I thought it was a planet but it was too bright." A strange craft was reported 50 minutes later by four people in Trowbridge. Witness Nichola Winney said the object featured three lights in a triangle formation. She said it blocked out the stars as it passed overhead, making a soft droning sound as it moved. A UFO for sure, then.

DERBYSHIRE DALES -- The Matlock Mercury News of July 5, 2001, reports, L. Alison (29) of Lant Lane says "I was watching Big Brother and nothing usually drags me away from that!" she joked. Software sales executive Alison watched the UFO for around 30 seconds at 10:35 PM. She described it as disk-shaped and having four green flashing lights, arranged in a square. "I'm not a freak!" she insisted. "I'm not mad and I've never ever seen anything like this before. "It was huge and must have been 1,000 feet high. It was nothing like an aeroplane or a star. Someone else must have seen it." The craft made no movement. Alison stepped outside to call her boyfriend from their garage so he could share in the strange close encounter. L. Alison's sighting is now the 27th in the Derbyshire Dales since last September. The region is becoming widely known as a UFO hotspot among enthusiasts and features extensively on websites all over the world. Fox TV in America is filming a documentary about the famous Bonsall sighting in October and Nottingham's Four Sheets Films is shooting another about the wider picture.

MALVERN HILLS -- On July 1, 2001, a mass of yellow and orange flame was seen over the Malvern Hills, emitting a shower of sparks and a strange trail of vapour at 7:10 AM. Jon Percer, of Welland, spotted the strange object and alerted his wife Mary. "It wasn't going very fast and the vapour trail didn't get any longer." The couple watched the object for several minutes before it disappeared over the hills. A spokesman for the Royal Air Force said there were no operational air bases nearby. Aegean Airspace Challengers ... From Outer Space?

A T H E N S, Aug. 8 - Greek and Turkish air force pilots, sharing contested Aegean airspace, are used to seeing a fighter or two of their usually friendly adversary looping around them, or diving to intercept their patrol or training flights.

But for two Turkish trainee pilots, the aerobatics were different this time.

While on a routine training flight in a U.S.-made T-37 off the Turkish Aegean coastal town of Candarli, they suddenly had reason to call their home base control tower.

A bright object had approached their plane at high speed and reportedly gyrated around them for about a half-hour.

The Turkish newspaper *Hurriyet* quoted their call: "Object approaching the wings. Now it's behind the plane ... now it's in front of us." They told their controller and the regional war alert centre of the Turkish army that the apparent Unidentified Flying Object had an unusual shape that looked like a cross between a cone and a disc.

A Widely Curious Incident

Turkish air force sources said they were investigating. So were the neighbouring Greeks.

The Turks were planning to report the encounter to international bodies - especially the U.S. National Aeronautics and Space Administration.
