

**A TIME FOR CONSIDERATION**

Ufologists have always found themselves weighing a series of alternative views of unusual evidence, accounts frequently barely credible and sometimes even frightening. It is the nature of the case that absolutely hard and incontrovertible facts are seldom available. There is no case known to us that cannot be challenged in one respect or another.

It is, however, from the accumulation of multiple reports that a degree of certainty can eventually be obtained. There would have to be an incredible sort of conspiracy to deceive the public, one which keeps on producing extraordinary reports from a variety of sources world wide, to permit the view that there is no truth in any of them to be tenable.

This issue alone produces a plethora of reports verging often on the barely credible in one respect or another. Taken individually, they do not compel belief, but collectively the whole arcana of UFO witness reports adds up to more than the sum of its parts. Coincidences do indeed occur, but so many, so often? Roswell and Rendlesham are the classic cases where the evidence for UFO intervention is strongest, and if they are valid, then clearly that validity also lends support to other less well documented happenings.

The authenticity of UFO phenomena is too well attested to be dismissed as fiction.

**THE COMET THAT SPEAKS SUMERIAN**

On July 4th 2005, a NASA spacecraft named Deep Impact thrust out a metal probe devised to collide with a comet named Tempel-1. The purpose of the planned collision was to ascertain the true makeup of such a primordial comet by observing and analyzing the impact and its resulting debris.

The successful collision, observed from the spacecraft and a variety of Earth-placed and Earth-orbiting instruments, caused a spectacular flare and an expanding ball of ejecta. As the reports of what had been observed begin to trickle out, it becomes evident that the scientific community is facing a major puzzle: the blast, instead of confirming the comet as a celestial body formed in the solar system's deep-frozen outer fringes, "set loose key ingredients of Earth" (according to the headline in the San Francisco Chronicle of 9/9/05).

Among the perplexing emerging findings are these:

- Comets are described as 'frozen balls of dirty ice'; the findings from Tempel-1 indicate that it is made of broken-up rocks that contain clays and carbonates -- the **minerals of limestones and seashells that are formed only in liquid water.**

"How do clays and carbonates form in frozen comets where there isn't liquid water?" asked Dr. C.M. Lisse, a Mission scientist, according to the New York Times of September 7, 2005; "Nobody expected this," he said.

- The Spitzer space telescope also detected in Tempel-1 crystalline silicates - a form of the mineral that requires at least **1,300 degrees Fahrenheit temperatures** to form.

"How do you put that stuff into a comet that forms out by Pluto?" asked the puzzled Dr. Lisse. How, indeed, do you get mineral-melting temperatures in a region of absolute cold?

...And Life's Chemicals Too

Reporting some of the initial puzzling findings at a scientific meeting at Cambridge University in England on September 7-8, 2005, Dr.

Lisse (of John Hopkins University), Dr. Michael A'Hearn (University of Maryland) and other scientists expanded the list of Earthlike components discovered in the comet to include chemicals associated with **living organisms**.


They listed (in addition to clays and silicates) carbonates, iron sulphides, alumina, and compounds called PAHs, "which are among many organic chemicals that show up in living organisms on Earth."

Another reported surprise: "The team has detected an unexpectedly high concentration of methyl cyanide; biologists say methyl cyanide is a key player in reactions that form DNA" (*Christian Science Monitor*).

### A Comet in The Wrong Place

Comet Tempel-1 is not a new comet. It was discovered in 1867 by Ernst W. L Tempel of Marseille, France, and its very short period of less than six (Earth) years was determined that same year by C. Bruhns of Leipzig, Germany. It was thereafter observed on and off until it and its slightly changed orbit were re-determined in 1963 by the American astronomer B.G. Marsden.

The Orbit of Comet Tempel 1



"Comets form way out in the frigid edges of the solar system, and their nuclei remain deeply frozen during most of their passage through the inner solar system," said Dr. Lisse in pointing out the problems astronomers and astrophysicists now face.

Yet it is beyond doubt that the comet has been orbiting the Sun in a relatively limited and nearby part of the solar system, between Mars and Jupiter, as the NASA-released skymap (printed above) shows:

How then do we explain this "wrong place" of comet Tempel-1? Dr. Lisse rejected speculation that the comet "migrated to the warmer inner solar system within the last 10,000 years." Indeed, were it ever formed out there in the deep freeze, it would not be so Earthlike in all the other respects enumerated above.

### The Sumerian Solution


In fact, there seems to be only one simple solution to the host of enigmas now puzzling the scientists:

- Comet Tempel-1 is where it is because it was 'born' there, between Mars and Jupiter;
- It is Earthlike in its components because it and the Earth were 'born' of the same planetary 'mother'.

Readers of my books will hardly need reminding that that planetary mother was called TIAMAT in the Sumerian Epic of Creation - a text deemed by scholars to be an allegory, a myth, a religious text -- but treated by me in *The 12th Planet* and *Genesis Revisited* as a sophisticated cosmogony dealing with the creation of our Solar System and the fate of Tiamat, a watery planet that had existed in the space between Mars and Jupiter and was destroyed in a celestial collision with an Invader-planet (Nibiru). As a result of the collision:

- Half of Tiamat was smashed to bits and pieces to become the asteroids and short-term comets that orbit between Mars and Jupiter;
- The other half was thrust closer to the Sun to become planet Earth;
- The leading large satellite of Tiamat ("Kingu") was carried along to become Earth's Moon;

- Tiamat's other ten satellites were broken up to become comets, especially those with retrograde orbits.



Sumerian texts dealing with Nibiru explicitly state that, during the collision, the life-bearing Nibiru transferred the “seed of life” - what we now call **DNA** and the “chemicals of life”— to the vanquished Tiamat, and thus to Earth and, we can now realize, to an asteroid called Tempel-1.

**The Sumerian texts, as I expounded them, answer all the puzzles flowing from the Tempel-1 collision.**

So, Now That Science Has Caught Up...

Even before this more detailed (but not yet full) extent of the discoveries that puzzle astronomers and astrophysicists was

publicized, keen-eyed fans of mine have sent to me congratulatory messages: Your 12th Planet theories have just been proved!

I of course appreciate the compliments; but I remain doubtful regarding the outcome of this one more “so now that you were proven right...” As readers of this website (or participants in my seminars) know, it is not the first time that scientific discoveries “prove me right.” Indeed, the subtitle of *Genesis Revisited* was (already in 1990) “Is Modern Science Catching Up With Ancient Knowledge?”

Modern science continues to catch up with ancient knowledge, but stubbornly the scientists continue to ignore it.

## THE DEEP DARK SECRET AT DULCE

Dulce is a sleepy little town in northern New Mexico of about 900 population, located above 7,000 feet on the Jicarilla Apache Indian Reservation. There is only one major motel and a few stores. It is not a resort town and it is not bustling with activity. But, according to a few outsiders, Dulce harbours a deep, dark secret. The secret is harboured deep below the tangled brush of Archuleta Mesa. The secret is said to be a joint government-alien biogenetic laboratory designed to carry out bizarre experiments on humans and animals.

New Mexico State Police Officer Gabe Valdez was drawn into the mysteries of Dulce when called to investigate a mutilated cow in a pasture 13 miles east of Dulce on the Manuel Gomez ranch. Gomez had lost four cattle to mutilations between 1976 and June 1978 when a team of investigators which included Tom Adams arrived from Paris, Texas to examine the site of the carcasses.

Curious as to how cattle were being selected by the mysterious mutilators, an interesting experiment was conducted on July 5, 1978 by Valdez, Gomez, and retired scientist Howard Burgess. They pinned up about 120 of the Gomez

beef cattle and moved them through a squeeze chute under an ultraviolet light. They found a "glittery substance on the right side of the neck, the right ear, and the right leg." Samples of the affected hides were removed as well as control samples from the same animals. Schoenfeld Clinical Laboratories in Albuquerque analyzed the samples and found significant deposits of potassium and magnesium. The potassium content was 70 times above normal.

Some investigators attribute the mutilations to aliens from UFOs. UFOs have been seen frequently around Dulce. Sightings of strange lights and other aerial phenomena have been reported in many areas where the cows have been found at the time of the reported mutilation.

On April 19, 1988, I arrived in Dulce to visit with Gabe Valdez and inquire about the sightings, the mutilations, and the rumours of an underground alien base. Snow was still on the ground. I checked into the Best Western Motel and called Valdez to make an appointment to see me at 9:30 p.m. I found Gabe to be a very congenial host, offering to show me around the roads of Dulce that night and point out some various locations where he had found mutilated cows or seen strange aerial lights. He made the astounding statement that he was still seeing unidentified aircraft at the rate of one every two nights. We took a look at the Gomez Ranch, the road by the Navajo River, and the imposing Archuleta Mesa. Gabe had found landing tracks and crawler marks near the site of the mutilations, and was convinced that scientist Paul Bennewitz of Thunder Scientific Labs in Albuquerque was definitely on the right track in his attempts to locate the underground alien facility in the vicinity of Dulce. No one knew for sure where the facility was located or how humans or aliens gained secret entry to the facility.

I had first heard of Paul Bennewitz in 1980 when my friend Walter called me from Albuquerque and told me he had been working with Paul on electronic instruments. Walter informed me that Paul had not only photographed UFOs, but had established a communication link with their underground base at Dulce. Bennewitz had first come to prominence during the August 1980 sightings over the Manzano Weapons Storage Area at Kirtland Air Force Base. A Kirtland AFB incident report dated October 28 1980 mentions that Bennewitz had taken film of the UFOs over Kirtland. Paul, who was president of the Thunder Scientific Labs, which were adjacent to Kirtland, gave a briefing in Albuquerque detailing how he had seen the aliens on a video screen. At the time the aliens were transmitting signals to him from a base underneath Archuleta Mesa.

Researcher William Moore claims that the government agents became interested in Bennewitz's activities and were trying to defuse him by pumping as much disinformation through him as he could absorb. Whether Paul's communication with supposed aliens at the Dulce Base was part of this disinformation campaign is unclear. If we believe that Paul is the single source of reports on the Dulce Facility, then discounting Paul's story and discrediting

him could be a tactical manoeuvre. The actual disinformation manoeuvre would result in making the public believe there was nothing to the Dulce story.

In a report entitled "PROJECT BETA," Paul states that he had spent two years tracking the alien craft; that he had constant reception of video from an alien ship and an underground base view-screen; that he had established constant direct communications with the aliens using a computer and a form of hexadecimal code with graphics and print-out; and claims to have used aerial and ground photography to locate the alien ship's launch ports and charged-beam weapons. Paul claimed that the aliens were devious, employed deception, and did not adhere to agreements. He and Walter were working on a weapon that would counter the aliens.

Have we crossed over from the land of the real world to the land of science-fiction? But then, bizarre phenomena may have its roots in a bizarre reality. As we continue our studies, the world of science-fiction will become the world of science-fact.

Paul Bennewitz had investigated the case of abductee Myrna Hansen of New Mexico, who reported having been taken to an underground facility in May 1980. Christa Tilton of Oklahoma claims she had an experience of missing time in July 1987, when she had been abducted by two small grey aliens and transported in their craft to a hillside location where she encountered a man dressed in a red military-type jump suit. She was taken into a tunnel through computerized checkpoints displaying security cameras. She reports having been taken on a transit vehicle to another area where she stepped on a scale-like device facing a computer screen. After the computer issued her an identification card, she was told by her guide that they had just entered Level One of a seven-level underground facility. Christa goes on relating how she was eventually taken down to Level Five, where she reports having seen alien craft and little grey alien entities in some of the areas that she passed through.

In one large room where she saw computerized gauges hooked to large tanks and large arms that extended from some tubing down into the tanks. She noticed a humming sound, smelled formaldehyde, and had the impression that a liquid was being stirred in the tanks. She was not shown the contents of these tanks. Christa has made drawings of much of what she claims to have witnessed during her abduction.

These tanks were also depicted in a set of controversial papers called the "Dulce Papers," which were allegedly stolen from the Dulce underground facility along with over 30 black-and-white photos and a videotape. The mysterious security officer who took the papers claims to have worked at Dulce until 1979, when he decided that the time had come to part company with his employers.

## IS SOMEONE KILLING OUR UFO INVESTIGATORS?

*Part two of this article by Professor G. Cope Schellhorn follows on from part one that was featured in the last issue of Pegasus*

*Certainly neither the public at large, nor even UFOlogists generally, seem thoroughly aware of the real risks that UFO investigators run. In fact those UFOlogists who are aware of the suspicious deaths of some of their colleagues in the 50s and 60s seem to believe that whatever forces and agencies were then responsible have softened their tactics in the '80s and '90s. The evidence, as we have indicated, does not seem to support such a conclusion. There is no doubt, however, that the '50s and '60s produced some strange goings-on.*

### **Jessup and McDonald**

Undoubtedly the most intriguing (and perhaps appalling) deaths in UFOlogy were those of Dorothy Kilgallen, M.K. Jessup and Dr. James McDonald - the former an alleged accident, the latter two purported suicides. The details of these deaths, despite official pronouncements to the contrary, are disturbing to say the least. Each of the three individuals seemed to have much to live for, all were successful, and every one of them was deeply immersed in the relatively new UFO-phenomena problem.

### **Dorothy Kilgallen**

Dorothy Kilgallen was the most famous syndicated woman journalist of her day. Stationed in England in 1954-55, and privy to the highest levels of English society and its secrets, she wired two unusual dispatches which may have contributed to her death. The first, sent in February 1954, mentioned a "special hush-hush meeting of the world's military heads" scheduled to take place the following summer. The 1955 dispatch, which barely preceded her death from an alleged overdose of sleeping pills and alcohol (à-la Marilyn Monroe), quoted an unnamed British official of cabinet rank: "We believe, on the basis of our inquiry thus far, that saucers were staffed by small men -- probably under four feet tall. It's frightening, but there is no denying the flying saucers come from another planet."

Whatever the source (rumoured to be the Earl of Mountbatten), this kind of leak in the atmosphere of the mid- 50s was an unacceptable leak. It is well to recall that the secret CIA-orchestrated Robertson Panel had met in 1953 and issued the Robertson Report. Briefly summarized, this document -- and the attitudes reflected there -- represented a new hard-line attitude to covering up all significant UFO phenomena. The year 1953 and the meeting of the Robertson Panel truly initiated the UFO cover-up as we know it today, with a few extra dollops having been added.

Did Dorothy Kilgallen actually commit accidental suicide? There appears to be an excellent chance that she had help.

**Dr. James McDonald**, senior physicist, Institute of Atmospheric Physics and also professor in the Department of Meteorology at the University of Arizona, died in 1971, purportedly of a gunshot wound to the head. There is no-one who had worked harder in the 60s than McDonald to convince Congress to hold serious, substantial subcommittee meetings to explore the UFO reality, of which he was thoroughly convinced. He was definitely a thorn in the side of those who maintained the official cover-up and, needless to say, his passing would to them be a blessing.

McDonald, allegedly depressed, shot himself in the head. But, alas, he didn't die. He was wheelchair-ridden but somehow, several months after his first attempt, he allegedly got into an automobile, drove to a pawnshop, purchased another pistol from his wheelchair, drove to the desert and did himself in. How convenient, one might say, for his adversaries. And McDonald, there can be no doubt, had made enemies. The question is: how much did these enemies aid and abet the demise of this most worthy and influential campaigner?

### **Astronomer Mil Jessup**

When astronomer and archaeologist M. K. Jessup allegedly committed suicide in Dade County Park, FL., in 1959 certain alarm bells should have gone off. There is no doubt the well-known author of such influential works as *The Case for the UFO* and *The Expanding Case for the UFO* had been depressed. Things had not been going well for him, and he had, it must be admitted, indicated his gloom to close friends, Ivan Sanderson, the biologist, and Long John Nebel, the well-known New York City radio host. Sanderson reported him disturbed by "a series of strange events" which put him "into a completely insane world of unreality."

Was the reality that Jessup was facing at the time "completely insane" or were there, perhaps, forces driving Jessup towards the edge, forces with a plan? Anna Genzlinger thoroughly investigated his death. Her conclusion: "He was

under some sort of control." Remember, these were the days of secret governmental mind-control experiments which have only recently been uncovered.

Certain facts about the case raise red flags. For example, no autopsy was performed, contrary to the state law. Sergeant Obenclain, who was on the scene shortly after Jessup's body was discovered, has said for the record, "Everything seemed too professional." The hose from the car exhaust was wired on; and it was, strangely, washing machine hose. Jessup died at rush hour, with more than the usual amount of traffic passing by. He had been visited by Carlos Allende three days before his death and, according to his wife, had been receiving strange phone calls. We know the navy was very interested in what he was doing; and we all know, or should know, it is the ONI (Office of Naval Investigations) that has been in the forefront, from the very beginning, of the UFO cover-up.

And what matters of particular interest was Jessup investigating at the time? Something that was top secret and would remain so for some time: the Philadelphia Experiment.

#### Frank Edwards

Frank Edwards, the noted news commentator, died of an alleged heart attack on June 24, 1967, on the 20th anniversary of the Kenneth Arnold sighting. Was that coincidence?

Probably not. Several other prominent UFOlogists died the same day: **Arthur Bryant**, the contactee, **Richard Church**, chairman of CIGIUFO, and **Willie Ley**, the space writer. The circumstances surrounding the death of Edwards, who, like James McDonald, was pushing for meaningful Congressional subcommittee meetings, raise huge questions. It so happens that a "World UFO Conference" was being held in New York City at the Commodore Hotel on that very day in June, chaired by UFO publisher and author Gray Barker. Barker stated publicly that he had received two letters and a telephone call threatening that Frank Edwards, who was not in attendance, would not be alive by the conference's end.

It definitely looks like someone was sending a message. As an unhappy sequel to this account, **Rep Rouse**, who had been supporting Edwards in his campaign for Congressional attention to the UFO issue, died of a similar heart attack shortly afterwards.

The annals of UFOlogy are frighteningly filled with the deaths of UFOlogists from unusual cancers, heart attacks, questionable suicides and all manner of

strange happenings. Did former Defense Secretary **James Forrestal** really commit suicide, as reported, by jumping out a hotel window at about the time saucers may have been crashing down in the south-western desert? Was UFO writer **Damon Runyon, Jr.**'s suicidal plunge off a Washington D.C. bridge in 1988 really an act of will? What really happened to **Dr. B. Noel Opan** who, in 1959, after an alleged visit by MIBs, disappeared, as did **Edgar Jarrold**, the Australian UFOlogist, in 1960.

How do we explain the rash of heart attacks that took so many: **Frank Edwards**, **Rep Rouse**, author **H. T. Wilkins**, **Henry E. Kock**, publicity director of the Universal Research Society of America, author **Frank Scully** and contactee **George Adamski**? How do we correlate accurately the large number of purported suicides, including: **Rev. Della Larson**, contactee, author **Gloria Lee (Byrd)**, **Marie Ford**, the UFO enthusiast who discovered Larson's body, researcher **Doug Hancock**, and, more recently, researcher **Feron Hicks**? What do we do with the inordinately large number of cancer deaths which pepper the UFO field and which burn doubtful holes in our credulity: Canadian researcher **Wilbert B. Smith**, Brazilian researcher **Dr. Olavo Fontes**, **Jim and Coral Lorenzen**, and the deaths of biologist **Ivan Sanderson** and CUFO founder **James A. Hynek** (both from rare brain cancers)?

Certainly not all of these individuals, as well as many other less prominent researchers that limitations of space do not allow us to mention, were marked for termination. Many, perhaps most, died natural deaths. But so many of the cases leave doubt; some seem to be branded by the mark of Cain. We know now how easy it is to induce strokes and heart attacks through chemicals, pulsed beams and microbes. We have learned that the federal government was (and still is) involved in PSI-tech research. An individual's mind is rather easily manipulated, and minds can be subtly beaten like putty into despair and madness.

UFOlogy is not the safe, hobby-like pastime some would wish it to be. There is danger, real danger in sticking your nose in places where the powers that be don't want you to be. Many of the deaths related above are highly suspicious. Some appear to be outright murder.

What is the cause, who is the villain? Again, it must be emphasized that the "problem" is complex. Rogue intelligence agencies, negative ET groups, freelancing PSI-tech firms, and reactionary cultist groups all seem to play, or to have played, a part in the more nefarious UFO-related events described here, including the possible homicides of UFO researchers in past decades, as well as more recently. It seems highly likely that sometimes one or more of

these agencies may be working together, either with or without the knowledge of the other's presence.

What can we do about such a state of affairs? Several things. We can inform ourselves like good democratic citizens. And we can inform others. We can and must raise a hue and cry when we suspect foul play. If we are to protect our very lives and the democratic hopes we say we cherish, then we must not go, silent and ignorant, into the night, pretending an innocence we have not earned.

WBCQ SHORT-WAVE RADIO TALK-SHOW HOST WILLIAM "BILL" COOPER SHOT DEAD!

Eager, AZ -- Short-wave radio talk show host William "Bill" Cooper was shot dead last night during a gun-battle with the Sheriff's Deputies. According to Detective Frank Valenzuela of the Arizona Department of Public Safety, the shooting took place at 11:40 PM outside of Cooper's home at 96 North Clearview Circle, Eager, AZ.

Det. Valenzuela stated that Deputies from the Apache County Sheriff's Department were attempting to serve an arrest warrant upon Mr. Cooper. The Warrant, issued by the Round Valley Judicial Precinct in Springerville, AZ charged Cooper with one Count of Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon, and two Counts of "Endangerment." The Warrant was issued on August 29, 2001 for an incident which allegedly took place on July 11, 2001. The Court Case Number on the Warrant is CR-01-0310. Neither Valenzuela nor the Apache County Attorney's Office would reveal the name of the alleged victim(s). They did say the complaint was signed by Detective Paul Kirkum of the Eager, AZ Sheriff's Dept.

According to Valenzuela, Police had intelligence that Cooper had a large quantity of weapons in his home, and possibly explosives. Valenzuela also said the police knew that during his radio show on WBCQ, Cooper repeatedly stated that he "would kill any law enforcement officers that tried to take him." As such, the Sheriff's Department wanted to arrest Cooper away from his home, so as to minimize the possibility of armed conflict.

According to police, Cooper lived on a hilltop overlooking several undeveloped areas and other homes below. Despite not owning the land below his home, Cooper was known to chase teenagers or young lovers off the land and the police decided to use this to lure Cooper away from his home. Det. Valenzuela stated that two undercover Sheriff's Deputies were sent in a pick-

up truck to the area below Cooper's home. There were also two uniformed Deputies in the bed of the pick-up. As expected, Cooper drove down to that area from his home and told the two undercover Deputies to leave.

But Cooper left and drove away toward his home before the undercover Deputies could do anything. While on his way back up the hill, a fully-marked Sheriff's patrol vehicle blocked the road (1) in front of Cooper. Uniformed members of the Sheriff's Department SWAT Team (2) exited that marked vehicle and told Cooper to stop, keep his hands where they could see them, and exit the vehicle. They say Cooper placed one hand outside his window, then accelerated around the police car, trying to run over a Sheriff Sergeant. Police gave brief chase to Cooper's home.

Police say Cooper exited his vehicle, drew a handgun and began firing at Deputies as he ran toward his house. One Deputy Sheriff was struck at least once and possibly twice in the head (3). Another Deputy returned fire, hitting Cooper several times.

The wounded Deputy was evacuated by helicopter to a hospital in Phoenix. Cooper was pronounced dead at the scene by Paramedics who were standing by at the scene (4).

The following questions arise from this incident:

- (1) Cooper would have had to pass the marked police patrol vehicle while going down the hill. Why would he do so without seeing it and fleeing? Further, how could he drive around it once it came onto the road while Cooper was *en route* back to his home?
- (2) If police intended a peaceful, non-violent arrest, why send a SWAT Team?
- (3) If Cooper drew a gun and fired "while running back toward his home" as police say, how could he hit a Deputy once, possibly twice, in the head? A head-shot is a difficult thing to accomplish with a hand gun, never mind two head shots while the shooter is running!
- (4) Why were Paramedics "on the scene standing by" if Sheriffs intended this to be a peaceful arrest?

These questions make The Hal Turner Show wonder if Bill Cooper was set up (*Editor's note: and mind controlled?*) to be gunned down, or just a victim of his own big mouth and prudent police planning? We pray for the soul of Mr. Cooper, and for the life of the Deputy shot in the head.

### Stanley Kubrick

While not a UFO researcher, I feel that Stanley Kubrick deserves a mention here. I believe that Stanley Kubrick, who died shortly after the release of his movie *Eyes Wide Shut* was killed by advanced technology. 
### Dean Stonier

## **Former Canada Defense Minister Hellyer Speaks Out on ETs & Government Secrecy**

On September 25 2005 Hon. Paul Hellyer, the former Canadian Minister for National Defense, gave a speech in Toronto at an event titled: *Exopolitics Toronto: A Symposium on UFO Disclosure and Planetary Direction* (www.exopoliticstoronto.com). Hellyer described his time as Minister for Defense from 1963-1967, when the occasional UFO sighting report crossed his desk. He claims never to have had time for what he considered to be a "flight of fancy", but nevertheless retained an interest in the UFO phenomenon. While Minister for Defense, he was guest of honour at the opening of the world's first UFO landing pad at Alberta, Canada in 1967. He thought it an innovative idea from a progressive Canadian community willing to pay for his helicopter ride, but did not give much thought to UFOs as having serious policy implications. He also describes a private UFO sighting he later had with family and guests, but once again attributed it to a 'flight of fancy' rather than anything having serious policy implications.

Hellyer's position on UFOs dramatically changed after watching the late Peter Jennings' documentary special *Seeing is Believing* in February 2005. Hellyer decided to read a book that had been idly sitting on his book shelf for two years. Philip Corso's *The Day After Roswell* sparked intense interest for Hellyer in terms of its policy implications. Corso named real people, institutions and events in his book that could be checked. Intrigued by the policy implications, Hellyer decided to confirm whether Corso's book was real or a "work of fiction". He contacted a retired United States Air Force General and spoke to him directly to verify Corso's claims. The unnamed General simply said: "every word is true and more". Hellyer then proceeded to discuss the "and more ..." with the general and claimed he was told remarkable things concerning UFOs and the extraterrestrial hypothesis that interplanetary visitors have been here since at least 1947. Finally convinced that the UFO phenomenon was real, Hellyer decided to come forward and speak at *Exopolitics Toronto* about some of the "most profoundly important policy questions that must be addressed." The policy questions Hellyer addressed in his talk are both profound and vitally important for citizens of every nation on Earth.

First, Hellyer claimed that evidence concerning UFOs is the "greatest and most successful cover up in the history of the world". He confirmed that senior political officials even at the rank of Minister of Defense, a position he himself occupied, are simply out of the loop when it comes to information

concerning UFOs and visiting extraterrestrials. From a democratic perspective, that raises many concerns about oversight, transparency and accountability of those in control of the information, technology and projects concerning the extraterrestrial visitors.

A second profound policy question concerns the designation by the U.S. military of visiting extraterrestrials as an 'enemy'. According to Hellyer, this had led to the development of "laser and particle guns to the point that they can be used against the visitors from space." It is this targeting of visiting extraterrestrials that concerns Hellyer, and he asks "is it wise to spend so much time and money to build weapon systems to rid the skies of alien visitors?" Hellyer poignantly raises the key policy question: "Are they really enemies or merely legitimate explorers from afar?" Hellyer's question raises profound importance in understanding the relationship between visiting extraterrestrial civilizations and world peace.

The third policy question arose from the recent decision by President Bush to build a base on the moon. Hellyer believes this is the activation of a plan first launched by Col Corso's mentor, Lt General Arthur Trudeau, to build a base from which visiting extraterrestrials could be monitored and possibly targeted as they approach the Earth. Hellyer outlined his opposition to the weaponization of space, something that the liberal government of Canada is currently opposed to. The weaponization of space remains a key policy issue clearly has profound policy issues from the perspective of extraterrestrial visitors to Earth.

Finally, Hellyer declared that the "time has come to lift the veil of secrecy" and to have an "informed debate about a problem that doesn't officially exist." Understanding the evidence concerning the UFO phenomenon is vital to fully preparing citizens around the world for the truth concerning extraterrestrials, despite official denial and secrecy by those "in the loop". He calls for major global initiatives to fully prepare global citizenry for the truth. He endorses a position taken by key exopolitical researchers such as Alfred Webre to prepare for a "Decade of Contact" where humanity is prepared for the truth about extraterrestrial visitors through informed debate and education.

Paul Hellyer is the first senior politician to openly come out and declare the truth about the extraterrestrial presence. He is blazing a trail that many other senior politicians are destined to take. It will be wise if the world's senior politicians quickly learn more about this remarkable Canadian statesman and heed his important advice about data on extraterrestrial visitors and the "profoundly important policy questions that must be addressed."

## Obituary – The Times October 18<sup>th</sup> 2005

**Graham Sheppard – December 11, 1942 - August 24, 2005**

**Pilot who risked professional censure for his readiness to speak publicly about unidentified flying objects.**

***[Members may recall Graham presenting a very well-attended lecture for SIGAP in Guildford during the mid 90s.]***

IF UFOs existed, airline pilots would probably be the people most likely to see them, track them and, with the help of their sophisticated equipment, gather the reliable technical data that makes a tall tale less easy to dismiss. It was Graham Sheppard's contention that pilots had been sighting unidentified craft experiencing regular near-misses for decades.

Sheppard was a telecommunications engineer and civil pilot who alarmed his superiors by speaking out about such experiences and, as he claimed, the danger to civil aviation of near-collisions and panic reactions in the face of unidentified craft.

His discussions with the press about his experiences led to his being censured in 1993, with the threat of dismissal from British Airways if he continued to air his views. After this he remained circumspect until his retirement. Thereafter he became a popular speaker at UFO conferences and seminars.

Sheppard was born in Pembrokeshire in 1942. His interest in UFOs was first aroused when, aged 11, he spotted something odd in the sky. Although he had a dream of becoming a pilot himself, he did not begin flying commercial aircraft until 1966. First he worked as a telecommunications engineer on a prototype modem — a room-sized technologically advanced device. During his time working for the Post Office he was also stationed at the Satellite Earth Station at Goonhilly Downs on the Lizard in Cornwall.

He subsequently trained at the BEA/BOAC College of Air Training at Hamble, Southampton, and graduated to fly as first officer on BOAC's Vickers Vanguard aircraft. In the next 30 years he flew almost every kind of aircraft, both passenger and cargo, for BOAC and then, on its amalgamation with BEA, for British Airways (BA). In the mid-1970s Sheppard would take a two-year sabbatical in Africa, flying a twin-

engined Britten-Norman Islander for Zambia's flying-doctor service; he later flew domestic routes in Malawi.

In 1967, on a flight from Scotland to London, Sheppard's crew were warned of "high-speed opposite direction traffic, identity unknown". Almost immediately Sheppard saw, so he reported, below him and about 300 metres to the west, a shining disc-shaped object which passed at a speed he estimated as being 1,300kmh. That same year, on a night flight to London from Gibraltar, he and his crew recorded what appeared to be an aerobatic display by two unidentified craft. The two objects were confirmed but not identified by radar in Bordeaux.

(Richard Haines, a Nasa research scientist and science director of the National Aviation Reporting Centre on Anomalous Phenomena (Narcap) states that since the early days of civil aviation pilots worldwide have made about 3,400 reports of unidentified craft.)

After speaking to journalists about his concerns over near-misses, Sheppard was summoned to the office of Lloyd Griffiths, British Airways' chief pilot for the Boeing 757 and 767 fleets. The correspondence that followed stated that "BA is not putting its collective head in the sand on this topic" but gave warning of the "media reaction involving ridiculing of your views and the subsequent damage of your image as a BA captain". It stated that Sheppard should be in no doubt about the "likely repercussions" of further disclosures.

He had, however, broken the silence and changed the atmosphere immeasurably. On February 2, 1995, *The Times* reported that a near-miss between a BA 737 with 60 passengers on board and an illuminated wedge-shaped object at 13,000 feet above the Pennines was under formal investigation by the Civil Aviation Authority. The conclusion, a year later, stated that: "Despite exhaustive investigation the reported object remains untraced", and the Joint Airmiss Working Group (JAWG) stated that it hoped this case "will encourage pilots who experience unusual sightings to report them without fear of ridicule," added that the pilots, Roger Wills and Mark Stuart, were the "latest in a long line of pilots to have faced the unmentionable". The pilots in this case had taken no evasive action; responding to gut instinct in other such cases has been known to stall aircraft. Knowing this, Sheppard briefed the JAWG in 1995, a year after his retirement from BA.

In 1989 he met and befriended the UFO researcher Timothy Good. In his book *Unearthly Disclosure* (2000), Good included an account of an experience in which, while flying a Cessna 172 from San Juan to

Mayagüez, Puerto Rico, Sheppard, after passing over the Arecibo radio telescope, suddenly found himself impossibly far off course. His instruments — still, apparently, functioning normally — had recorded that he had passed over hills 3,900 feet high while flying at a constant 2,200ft.

Sheppard was kept busy on the lecture and conference trail until incapacitated by myelofibrosis. He was a musical polyglot, able to play many instruments, but with a particular skill for jazz clarinet and saxophone. His abilities as a raconteur, and his ability to be always credible, as well as immensely likeable, brought great conviction, as well as entertainment, to any discussion of the unexplained in which he participated.

He is survived by his wife, Margaret, and by two sons from a previous marriage.

**Graham Sheppard, airline pilot, was born on December 11, 1942. He died on August 24, 2005, aged 62.**

## **BOOK REVIEWS:**

**THE SONG OF THE GREYS by Nigel Kerner.  
(Hodder & Stoughton, £7.99)**

Nigel Kerner's writing verges continually on the frantic and exasperated, frequently merely ranting. It is a 400-page shout and the reader is deafened by it -- which is a pity, for he does have something to say.

He introduces his topic thus: "They are the 'Greys', and their hands reach out urgently to seek their purposes in and within the bodies and the body of all Humanity. They are more. Much more. They are the tentacles of doom. They are the arms of Satan; for so long the talisman of all wrongs, of all evil, all sin in the history of Men."

An interesting start, you may say, but it goes on and on like that, always on the edge of hysteria.

The Greys, he tells us, are extraterrestrials who have lost their souls and have come to earth to steal ours. They have infinitely superior technology and entropy, the inevitable running down of everything, is on their side. They have subverted the rulers of our planet, so that there is "a cover-up of international proportions." A semi-lapsed Catholic who still defines himself as a Christian, Kerner yet doesn't expect God to save the situation. Evolutionary devolution is inevitable, he says, and we must save ourselves from the doom of eventually re-incarnating in a downward spiral from human to animal as our souls are lost to the invaders. "I am thoroughly convinced," he writes, "that we as a species are at the rim of a cataclysm if we don't expose the presence of an alien influence in the affairs of humanity."(p.401)

There may well, indeed, be some truth in much of what Kerner is saying, but mere assertion, however oft repeated, and urgency verging on panic, need factual support. Quotations from world religious leaders and avatars are not the evidence needed. His diagnosis is not without elements of plausibility, but any suggestion of effective remedy is buried in an inadequate ontological analysis. No valid answer emerges from all this passionate and verbose sermonising.

## **ASTRONAUT SAW ALIEN BODIES**

Clark C. McClelland, former ScO, Space Shuttle Fleet, Kennedy Space Center, Florida (1958-1992) writes, "Every generation has the obligation to free men's minds for a look at new worlds...to look out from a higher plateau than the last generation." Astronaut Lt. Col. Ellison Onizuka, USAF. Prior to the fateful launch of the space shuttle Challenger on January 28, 1986, I had the honour and pleasure of sharing conversations with several members of that crew.

During one of many pre-mission preps for the Challenger mission, I came upon Lt. Col. Ellison Onizuka in the Vehicle Assembly Building (VAB) at launch complex 39. Many astronauts at the KSC knew of my interest in the study of possible ET intelligence. Another evening while off-site, I once again accidentally came upon Ellison. He asked if I could give him an opinion regarding a topic that was sparking his curiosity. Ellison had a great interest in ET life and asked me my belief concerning aliens, and if I believed they have been here on earth? His question caught me by surprise. As we walked slowly, I briefly related what I knew regarding the Roswell case. Onizuka asked me if my surname had any connection with McClellan Air Force Base in California? I said not as far as I was aware. I asked him why.

Ellison said he had had a surprising experience, along with other USAF pilots, while on military training duty at McClellan AFB, about eight or nine years prior to his astronaut training. He and this group were at this base for specialized training when they were directed to report to a viewing room. As they were seated, the room darkened and a movie began without the usual official introduction by a USAF officer. They were all startled when a view of a facility similar to a medical examination room appeared on the screen and small bodies were observed lying on slabs. He heard several excited comments by the other officers seated near him. The small, strange-looking creatures were humanoid in shape and appeared similar to those described by

alleged witnesses at the well-known Roswell site in the south-west USA in 1947. They all had large heads, large eyes, slight torsos, arms, and legs. They did not appear to be of earthly origin. Ellison then said: "Clark, my God, these highly-trained officers and I were shocked by what we saw. We were not made privy to what we would see until it happened. We were all caught off guard. Perhaps it was a test of our psyche to determine our overall reaction. Well, we were all caught by surprise".

## **NEWS IN BRIEF/ SIGHTINGS ROUNDUP**

### **Radars and satellites picking up UFOs -**

Since 11 September 2001 NORAD fighters have scrambled or diverted from air patrols in the U.S. Northern Command Area of Responsibility more than 2,000 times to respond to possible air threats, and have combined with Airborne Warning and Control System (AWACS) and air-to-air-refuelling aircraft to fly more than 40,000 sorties.

Joe Stefula reports: "Our DSP satellites track the launch of various missiles using various types of sensors but chiefly with Infrared sensors. In addition to the missiles the sensors are also able to pick up unidentified flying objects called Fastwalkers that are entering and leaving our atmosphere." Slower anomalous objects

are referred to as Slowwalkers. The DSP satellite system once composed of 18 units in deep space orbit picks up UFO intruders or "Fastwalkers" several times a week. AeroJet General Engineer Ron Regehr helped design the satellites. Insiders report there is a great deal of excitement as the UFOs sometimes trigger the early-warning system. Often they are referred to as Uncorrelated Targets, indicating they are not in the database for objects in space. Source: Filer's Files

**French Government to recommence UFO study** -The French Government, and its official national space agency CNES, will restart its official UFO study program. The French government has for several decades had an official program to study UFOs, called GEPAN / SEPRA. It was closed recently, but after an audit, it will now be restarted, with a new director, Yves Sillard. This program is an official French government project, and is conducted under the official French space agency CNES (the equivalent of NASA in the US). The new director was a former director of CNES, and has numerous other high positions and achievements to his credit. In an interview with him he seems to express very strong support for the subject of UFOs, and advocates the need for serious, rigorous scientific study of the phenomenon. Mr. Sillard's most recent position was Assistant Secretary General for Environmental and Scientific Affairs for NATO.
