+ CIGAR-SHAPED OBJECT OVER GATWICK AIRPORT +

Mr. A. G. Pyatt, a salesman, of 39A Burnbury Road, London S.W. 12, saw a UFO over Gatwick Airport at 5.10 p.m. on June 30. A Mrs. Ingersoll, who was with Mr. Pyatt at the time, also saw the object. (S.98)

Says Mr. Pyatt: "Whilst driving from Lowfield Heath to Charlwood I noticed a bright object in the sky. As it was in line with the Gatwick Airport runway I thought it was an aeroplane, but it did not appear to be moving. It seemed to be hovering in the sky. I was not able to determine its exact shape, but it seemed to be cylindrical and not of aircraft shape. The object was in my view for three to four minutes".

This particular sighting was investigated by S.I.G.A.P. member Mr. R. J. A. Snow. He says in his report: "Normally at Gatwick Airport there is a lot of noise when aircraft are taking off or are in flight. However, at the time when the object was sighted, the observer claims that no noise was to be heard. He was very specific about this point. In my mind this story is true and accurate. Both the observer and his witness were not firm believers of UFOs. I have known Mr. Pyatt, who is middle-aged, for some years. On further questioning I discovered that the object eventually completely disappeared, without any sound or trace.

A silver, very bright, classic "flying-saucer" shaped object was seen by Miss Ellinor Austen, of 14 Heatherbank, Tower Road, Hindhead, at 1.30 a.m. on July 6. She was standing outside her house at the time. The sky was clear and stars were visible. Said Miss Austen: "I had the feeling that the object contained instruments and people".

Mr. R. K. Thackray, a member of S.I.G.A.P., saw a "very bright large white light" over the Hogs Back at 11.25 p.m. on July 3. Mr. Thackray, who lives at Laburnam Cottage, Beary Lane, Fox Corner, Worpleston, was in Elstead at the time. The object was seen too by a John Enever and Stuart Reffold. (S.108)

Mr. Thackray says in his report:- "It was a bright night with scattered hazy cloud. I was looking out from Elstead village towards the Hogs Back. The skyline of the Hogs Back was clearly visible against the bright sky. Suddenly I saw a bright light moving across the sky from west to east at a steady rate and at a constant height above the Hogs Back skyline. The object was the size of a pea held at arms length. Its brilliance was constant. When the object passed out of sight behind a tree I moved to a new position and saw it fading into the haze. I heard no aircraft noise and saw no aircraft navigation lights".

Two star-shaped UFOs which appeared to be joined were seen by Woolworths supervisor Mrs. Dorothy White and shop assistant Mrs. Irene Skinner at about 10.30 p.m. on June 13. (S.100a)

Mrs. White saw the objects from her home at 8 James Road, Peasmarsh, Guildford. Mrs. Skinner saw them from the back of Guildford's Odeon Cinema.

Mrs. White said: "I saw an extra large bright star with a smaller one underneath. The smaller one looked as if it was suspended from the one above. The bottom light was reddish and neither moved during the period of observation. I called my daughter to have a look at the objects and then we went indoors.

Mrs. Skinner's description of the objects was almost identical. She said: "They stood out as quite unusual, yet they looked exactly like stars. The objects did not change colour and they did not move".

Although S.I.G.A.P. observers saw nothing more spectacular than low cloud and the odd star or two during the Pewley Down Skywatch on June 15, this it seems, was far from the case in Wales, where the Welsh UFO Research Association (W.U.F.O.R.A.) also held an all-night skywatch.

Welsh S.I.G.A.P. member Mr. Derek Toombs, who lives in Abertillery, Monmouthshire, was one of the 20 who took part in the skywatch - on Caerphilly Mountain. He has sent S.I.G.A.P. a tabulated account of the unidentified objects seen during the night:-

- S.97.A. Time: 23.52-23.53
Whitish-yellow star-like object travelling from west to east. Its motion was zig-zag, pendulum and curved.
Weather: semi-clear, patches of cloud.

- B. Time: 02.10
Small white star-like object travelling from south to north in a zig-zag pattern. It made no sound. Ten people observed this UFO.
Weather: clear.

- C. Time: 03.04-04.15
One large object and five or six small green objects with vary luminosities observed. There was no sound and the objects behaved irregularly. The larger object was travelling from north-west to south-east. A formation of UFOs was also seen travelling from east to south in a diamond-shape formation.
Weather: quite hazy; thundery.

- D. Time: 03.48-04.04
An ellipsoidal-shaped UFO seen. Its length was more than three times its breadth. Colour: leading edge (facing north) green, trailing edge red-orange. It had a bright white central area sometimes appearing blue. The object was pulsating constantly.
Weather: clearing.

Another Surrey UFO has been reported by S.I.G.A.P. member Richard Colborne. He saw it while travelling to Woking at 4 a.m. on June 29 with a Mr. Edgar Ingrams. The object - yellow-white and cylindrical-shaped with tapered ends - was first seen in the sky above Guildford Technical College. It is interesting to note that it was below cloud level. Mr. Colborne and Mr. Ingrams followed the UFO by road for $\frac{3}{4}$ mile. It finally disappeared behind houses on Bellfields Estate.
