And you know what, they got their facts wrong and elaborated somewhat. SIGHTINGS came to Scotland to film SPI and psychical researcher Tony Cornell at Stirling Castle in regards to a spirit rescue. I recently saw a copy of the programme which was kindly sent to Scotland from the producer of the show, and instead of stating Stirling Castle, they stated using headings on screen, - Sterling Castle, they go on to say that Stirling Castle is the most haunted place in the world. What rubbish, it most certainly is not.

'Foo Fighters' of W.W. II.

(Editor's note. My thanks to Editor Duncan Roads of Australia's NEXUS magazine for permission to reprint the following article).

During World War II, the accumulation of sightings of mysterious celestial objects finally started to worry the military authorities. In both camps high ranking officials of the intelligence services started to study these strange objects and investigation committees composed of military and scientific personnel were set up in various countries. They had a double purpose, first of all to determine the nature of these flying objects, and then to see if they constituted a threat to the security of the nation.

During World War II the allies, just like the Germans, noticed the presence of these enigmatic flying objects above their secret bases. The first reaction of each side was obviously to suspect espionage on the part of their enemy. In 1943, the English were the first to set up a special group to enquire into the question of these objects. They set up a small organisation to collect evidence. This was headed by Lieutenant General Massey and was inspired by reports from a spy who in fact, was a double agent operating under the orders of the mayor of Cologne. He had confirmed that the "Foo Fighters" were not German devices, but that the Germans thought that they were Allied weapons which of course, the British knew was not so. Later in 1966, it was learned from the British Aviation Minister that project Massey had been officially classified in 1944. Perhaps it was pure coincidence, but the double agent was denounced and executed at the beginning of that year.

For their part, the Germans did not remain inactive. In 1944 the Wehmacht asked Oberkommando of the "Luftwaffe Aviation" to set up a centre to collect information on all the various sightings of these mysterious celestial objects. This was known as the Sonderburo No 13, which until the time of the German defeat, scrupulously applied itself to its job. The short time that this commission was in existence, prevented it from coming to any definite conclusions, but it collected an impressive amount of information. The first sighting studied by the Sonderburo, went back two years and came from a Hauptmann Fischer, an engineer in civil life, on March 14th, 1942, at 5.35pm, Fischer landed at the secret air base at Banak Norway.

At that instant the radar picked up a luminous object and Fischer was asked to go up and identify it. At about 10,000 feet, the pilot caught sight of the object and gave a description by radio to the base; an enormous streamlined craft about 300 feet long, and about 50 feet in diameter. The aerial whale, which was Fischer's title for it, stayed horizontal for a long moment before rising vertically and disappearing at great speed. It was not a machine constructed by the hand of man, Fischer stated in his report. On reading the report, Air Marshall Hermann Goering concluded that the solitude of the north does not seem to have done much for this pilot.

The report of another interesting incident was carefully preserved in the archives of the German Investigation Committee; that of the launching of an experimental rocket on February 12th 1944, at the Kummersdorf test centre. On that day, the Minister of propaganda Joseph Goebbels, S.S. Reichsfuhrer Himmler and S. Gruppenfuhrer Heinz Kammler, were present at the launching which was being filmed. Some days later, the authorities at the base organised a showing of the film. The astonished spectators could see very clearly, a spherical body which followed the rocket and circled around it.

The authorities immediately suspected Allied espionage. However, an agent informed Himmler that the English were themselves, victims of the same sort of phenomenon, and thought that it was a new type of German prototype craft. However, the most convincing evidence filed away by the Sonderburo came from a military flying ace.

On September 29th, 1944 at 10.45 am, a test pilot was trying out a new Messerschmitt jet ME 262 Schwalbe, when his attention was suddenly caught by two luminous points situated on his right. He shot at full speed in that direction, and found himself face to face with a cylindrical object more than 300 feet long, with some openings along its side, and fitted with long antennae placed in front up to about halfway along its length. Having approached within about 1,500 feet of the craft, the pilot was amazed to see that it was moving at a speed of more than 1,200 m.p.h.



At present, I am writing an extensively researched book about the Yowie mystery, which will include all the latest archaeological evidence for stone age occupation of Australia, as well as other evidence of another former giant hominid race here, their massive stone tools and fossil footprints. While reports of sightings of the Yeti and Bigfoot are always interesting to me, they are never as fascinating as those of Australia's Yowie (or great hairy man), a secretive race of man apes that have for too long been largely overlooked by the world's media. I would dearly love to be able to get it across to overseas reporters, like I am able to do here.

Australia's "Bigfoot" is to me, a breath of fresh air, a change from all the information one continually receives on the American/Himalayan manbeasts (and womanbeasts!) The Australian reports are often as fascinating as the American stories one reads in books, if not more so in many cases. If anything, my information from Australia I feel, is exciting, because it is hardly at all known overseas. I have a lot more surprises for you which I will be delighted to publish in ENIGMAS. 1992 Animal Mutilation Update By Linda Moulton Howe.



(Editor's note. I would like to thank Linda Moulton Howe for giving me permission to reprint the following article. Linda has promised SPI to keep us aware of this alarming problem which is still ongoing in the United States).

In the cold winter nights of December 1991 to January 1992, something was haunting Oklahoma, Kansas, and Missouri, leaving dead and mutilated cattle in its wake. One couple, driving down a country lane after dark, saw two bright objects moving low in the sky. "As one got over the road above us, it blinked out" said Mike Markum of Cement Oklahoma. Markum and his wife report that they have seen several "sparkler like balls" going over their house at low altitudes.

By the end of January, five Oklahoma Counties, had about 30 reports of mysteriously killed and mutilated animals. Even though the socially acceptable explanations in those counties are either Satanic cults or predators. Sheriff Archie Yearick of Grant County told me that he was puzzled "because there aren't ant tracks around any of these carcasses". That same comment has been made by law enforcement and ranchers since the animal mutilation mystery began in September 1967, when a horse named lady was found in the San Luis Valley of Colorado stripped of flesh from the neck up. Lady's hoof tracks stopped 100 feet from where her body was found. Residents had seen odd lights and 'small jets' moving low and rapidly over the desert. Worldwide news articles quoted speculations that UFOs and the mare's death were connected.

When I began research for my documentary "A Strange Harvest" in 1979 I did not set out to do a film about an alien life form connection.



but that's what I found in several eyewitness accounts of orange, silent, glowing objects the size of football fields hovering "above pastures" where mutilated animals were later found. Or beams of light observed shining down from 'silent helicopters' that lighted pastures 'brighter than daylight,' and the next day mutilated animals were found. And eyewitness reports of strange craft and/or nonhuman creatures involved with animals.

In 1983, a Missouri couple watching through binoculars as two small beings in tight fitting silver suits, "floated a paralyzed black cow into a craft" The alien heads were large and white coloured. Nearby, a tall green skinned "lizard man", stood glaring with eyes slit by vertical pupils like a crocodile's. In 1980, a Waco, Texas rancher watched one evening as two four foot tall creatures with large slanted black eyes carried a calf between them. He was terrified and ran away. Three days later he had the courage to go back to the scene with his wife and son. There they found the mutilated calf's body. The hide was completely intact and included the hooves, and the skull bone, but no other skeletal structure or muscles or internal organs. The hide was turned inside out, and folded neatly on the ground next to the backbone, from which all the ribs had been removed. That rancher asked me, "Who would do this, and what are they trying to tell us" ?

Since I began research into the animal mystery in 1979, no year has passed without mutilation reports, and 1992 was no exception. On January 25th 1992 near Okemah Oklahoma, a cow was found dead. The udder had been cut bloodlessly from the animal, the right chest was slit, and an Okfuskee County Sheriff Deputy assumed the heart had been removed. But no veterinarian was asked to do a necropsy. Without any hard evidence, the deputy's report simply said, "motive Satanic Ritual" But even he was surprised about how precisely the

cuts had been made without any blood residue. On Saturday February 2nd 1992, MUFON Oklahoma Investigator Chuck Pine travelled to Garfield, Kingfisher and Grant County Sheriff's offices to help me get more details about the January mutilations. Grant County Sheriff Archie Yearick said that that morning he had received a call from the police in Caldwell Kansas about a fresh steer mutilation there. So Chuck proceeded north over the border and travelled with a police officer to the mutilation site. Chuck retrieved tissue samples from the mutilator's cuts, as well as unaffected tissue for contrast, preserved them in formalin solution and sent them Federal Express to Dr. John Altshuler, pathologist and hematologist in Denver Colorado.

Dr. Altshuler and I have been working together since 1989 in an effort to gather as many animal mutilation tissue samples as possible for microscope examination. So far, the microscope has shown that tissue from animals, (including rabbits, deer, horses, and cattle) have been cut with high heat in the hundreds of degrees, as evidenced in the cooked hemoglobin and other cell changes. In one 1990 Oregon case, the tissue was serrated as if cut by pinking shears. Both Dr. Altshuler and the Oregon state Diagnostic Laboratory confirmed high heat had been used at the excision lines. The following Tuesday II 1992, there were two more reports of cattle mutilations at Calumet Oklahoma, 10 miles west of El Reno. The first was found by Robert Jacobs and his son. Half of the steer's tongue was removed, a bloodless oval incision had removed the genitals, and the rectum was cored out. No blood, no tracks. !

That evening, Travis (son of Robert Jacobs), took his girlfriend back to the field to show her what had happened. It was about 8. 15pm when they saw a light above our field. It was about 10 times brighter than a star. As we drove closer, we began to see different coloured lights on the edge. They were red, yellow, and blue and white. They flashed at random, not sequentially. When they got to within three quarters of a mile from the object, Julie the girlfriend, became frightened, and they returned to town. The object rose higher in the sky and followed them. "We were doing about 80, and by the time we reached town, it had gone past us".

After dropping Julie off at her house, Travis picked up his father and went back to the field where they saw the light again over the pasture. Robert Jacobs said he could clearly see the different coloured lights flashing on the object. They tried to approach it in the pick up, but the light moved away and disappeared. The following Monday afternoon, another steer, a hereford, was found dead and mutilated in the same Jacob's pasture. Like the February 6th Brahma

steer, the front half of the tongue had been removed, the left ear had been removed as if with high heat. A neat excision had removed the genitals, and the rectum was cored out. On March 3rd back in Okemah Oklahoma after midnight, three men saw a grey diamond shaped object with "windows" land and then take off. They estimated the diameter to be over 30 feet. A week later on March 9th, a cow was found with its udder cleanly and bloodlessly excised from the belly. There was also a large hole on the cow's left side. "Like a bullet hole", some said. But there was no exit hole, and no bullet. There was also blood on the ground near the cow's head which is not typical.

The next day on March the 4th, Benton County Sheriff Deputy Danny Varner went to meet Bill Cowger at Tyson's Hog Farms near Hiwasse Arkansas. An eight year old cow was lying on her right side. Her left eye was missing, the tongue had been removed, and a large piece of hide measuring 20 by 30 inches had been removed between the cow's back legs, taking the udder with it. The cut was only hide deep. The muscle tissue underneath was untouched. Sgt Varner wrote in his Investigation report,

"I found the cow's tongue had been removed by someone using a very sharp instrument. The tongue was cut diagonally from side to side, approximately six to eight inches from the cow's front teeth. The cow's left eye had been removed. The cow's udder and hide were removed by a very sharp instrument, no damage was done to the stomach wall, and the cuts looked to be that of a surgeon. The cow's vaginal area looked to be enlarged and pulled outwards. The ground surrounding the cow had no indications, (she) had struggled and I was unable to find any footprints around the cow. A small amount of blood was found on and around the cow."

February to March 1992, also included reports of two mutilated cows in Webster County, Missouri east of Springfield. At the same time, people were seeing strange lights in the sky over Northview. The Highway Patrol said so many people were parking along the I-44 Northview exit to look for UFOs, that it was a safety hazard. Tissue from nine of the mutilations was sent to Dr. Altshuler who found evidence of high heat at the excision lines and a hardened "plasticized" edge which is not consistent with typical lasers. Even a portable laser is the size of a large freezer, and requires a large electrical generator.

"If you could afford one, why would you lug it out to a field in the middle of the night where a farmer might take a shot at you for messing with his cows? Why not just buy your own cow?" Duanne Bedell asked. He is Co-State Section Director of the MUFON chapter in Webster County. "And how are the cows killed without a struggle no tracks and no blood"? One farmer, Joe Bouldin, said his cow's throat was slit, the esophagus was removed, and the teats were sliced off the udder. "But there were no marks on the ground anywhere, it's real mysterious", Bouldin said. A necropsy revealed most of the blood had been drained from the cow, but the ground was

dry. "How do you drain a cow of blood without spilling any"? Bouldin asked. "I've never carried a gun before in my life", Bouldin added, "but now we are carrying a loaded gun in our truck. That's about how I feel about all this". Another troubled farmer was Edwina Ragsdale. She said, "It's just like the cows were embalmed. We went out there last week (february 1992) and there was a faint smell of decay, but they should have been deteriorated by now". When asked what she thought was responsible, she said, "UFOs or cults, they both scare me to death".

S.P.I. CASE RESEARCH WORK.



SUBJECT. ALLEGED HAUNTING IN SAUCHIE CENTRAL SCOTLAND.

DATE OF INVESTIGATION. FROM FEBRUARY THE 8th, TO MARCH 1987.

(PART TWO).

(Editor's note. We learned from our last issue, of the ghostly manifestations occurring in a block of 3 houses together, and the subsequent involvement of SPI to try and ascertain what was going on. We left part one with the involvement of the Alloa Christian Spiritualist Church, this is what transpired next).

Having convinced the Alloa Christian Spiritualist Church of the seriousness of this case, SPI visited, along with some Church members, the house in question on the 16th of February, in an attempt to rid the houses of these strange occurrences. The following details, are extracts from my notes taken during this visit. After introductions to the three families involved, we separated into groups, some downstairs, (living room), and some upstairs, (Michelle's room) in which prayers were said in both rooms by the mediums of the Church. John Allardice, a local medium, related that he felt extreme heaviness in his head, and also heat throughout his body. Audio recordings were taken by SPI of this prayer session. Mr Allardice then perceived a voice come through asking for love, followed by a further two people who claimed

that they didn't want to be 'sent away'! I was at this time, upstairs in Michelle's room in which Emily Manini (local medium) was saying prayers. I remember that the whole room was bitterly cold, this might not have anything to do with spirits I told myself for it was February after all, but I do recall that my teeth were chattering quite loudly, and, 'embarrassingly'. Anyway, after Emily had finished saying her prayer, the silence in the bedroom was broken by the sound of a lady bounding up the stairs shouting at the top of her voice that Carol had been pushed off a wooden bench in the living room when no one was near her. Eleanor Power, who had been in Michelle's bedroom with me, said that moments before this lady came bounding up the stairs, she felt the room become 'warmer', as if what ever was in the room, "unseen", had went elsewhere, 'downstairs perhaps'? We all rushed downstairs in which we discussed this quite amazing incident.

After the excitement of what previously happened, psychic healing was administered to Carol, Eleanor, and the neighbour next door who was also 'troubled by psychic manifestations'. All was quite for now and the relaxing healing seemed to ease the situation. Now this is where I made a big mistake readers, and one in which I am still very much regretting. For I stupidly switched off the audio tape recorder during this quite healing session. For, some minutes later, the most strange and alarming look, came over Eleanor Power's face. A 'menacing piercing look' in which one felt they had to turn away from.

Suddenly, and quite unexpectedly, Eleanor stood up and started speaking in the most strangest voice, definitely unlike her own. From my notes, and sadly not from my audio tape, this is what Eleanor said." That took Lawrence away, they threw him down a hole, threw logs over him...I like it here, I don't want to go, They keep taking away my friends...My mum's name is Victoria... Men are going to get me...The men that threw Lawrence down the hole. They said that he was dead...We are not dead...Elona is the name of the baby....Lawrence is 30 now, I'm 25...I can't look round the room, because the men will get me...Please don't let me go away. If mummy comes they'll put her down the hole...I've got spots, but she and Lawrence can't be dead because of this baby. (Editor's note. Elona was the name of a baby that Eleanor had lost in child birth some four years previously)!"

All eyes were fixed on Eleanor as she continued to 'whirl about' and speak out in this strange manner. It honestly sent shivers down my spine. Eventually after some five minutes, Eleanor slumped into a nearby chair, 'wow' this was something else and totally unexpected, and all, "not" captured on audio tape. I could have kicked myself. This hole that Eleanor talked about, bothered me. I was aware that quite near this housing scheme, there were a number of old mine shaft entrances, (now bricked up) At a later date, a colleague and I visited these old mine shafts and took a number of photographs, of course, these may not have been the holes that Eleanor in this entranced state was referring to, but it was worth checking anyway. The spots that she mentioned, could this

have anything to do with a plague that went through parts of Central Scotland many years ago ? and which to some, would have proved unsightely and perhaps warrent death in order to keep it spreading to others ? The following day, a well known Stirling medium, a Mrs Jean Glenn, paid a visit to the home of Carol Harrison, nothing of any great significance came out of this visit, other than the medium picking up strong impressions from the home.

On the 18th of February, a colleague and I, were given permission to spend the night in the home of Carol Harrison. The family moved next door to sleep with their neighbours to let us have free run of the house. We set up our audio and video recording equipment at various points upstairs, afterwhich my colleague and I decided to check out the loft specifically to ensure that there were no hidden persons or appliances that might conduct noises, there were none. There were no signs of any devices that might have made raps or bangs, a point sceptics often make in regards to alleged paranormal noises.

After checking the loft with a weak flashlight and our imaginations running wild, (yes we Investigators are no heroes !) we came down and located ourselves at various points in the house to spend our night time vigil. My colleague stayed in Michelle's bedroom, scene of many of the disturbances, whilst I sat at the top of the stairs with a warm quilt wrapped firmly round my shoulders peering down into the inky blackness of the bottom stairway. The light from the moon shone between breaks in the cloud, through a window behind me illuminating parts of the upper hall, silence was every where, not a sound could be heard. And as usual, whenever psychic researchers are on a stake out, nothing happened. Most disappointing. Nothing was noted either on audio or video tape.

The family were most disappointed to learn that we had not experienced anything unusual in their home, indeed they were quite angry as if this might prove that they were mistaken in their judgements and misreading ordinary household noises. None the less, we kept our eyes and ears on the situation as the days grew on and we learned that things were not as bad as had been prior to the visit of the Alloa Spiritualists. Some days later, I was in a local pub having a quiet drink with a friend when my friend noticed an ex-boyfriend of Carol. "perhaps he could tell us something about this case", my friend surmised ! "possibly", I replied, and with that, I went over and explained who I was and touched briefly on the course of the SPI investigation. I should have known better ! for in mid sentance, this guy grabbed me by the throat and pushed me up against a wall. He just didn't believe me, he thought I was Carol's new boyfriend, I could hardly say otherwise for I could hardly breath !

I'll tell you this readers, that's the first time, and I hope the last, that I've ever been assaulted in my SPI research work. We Investigators don't lead the life of Riley you know. Anyway, eventually he did believe me, but he took some convincing I can tell you.

The outcome of this Investigation, was that Carol was re-housed (in the same town). Eleanor moved to Manchester, and the other lady is still residing at the same address. As for the strange events in the house ? Well they did die down a bit, and with the two familys moving, we never found out if the events stopped in their entirety. I mean, how can you go to a new tenneants door and say, "Hi", your house used to be haunted, could you tell me if it still is" ? You can't do it can you. This has always been a 'sticky one', and one that requires a lot of thought if one is thinking of checking again if the ghostly manifestations are recurring only this time with new tennants.

All in all then, this was a most interesting case, and although we researchers never saw or heard anything ourselves, it none the less was an experience for us. I would like to thank all those who assisted SPI in our case research work.

The Alvina Scott Abduction Case.



(Editor's note. We now continue with part 3 of our fascinating Canadian UFO abduction account. We take up from the August September 92 issue in which Alvina is relating her experiences under hypnosis, of her time aboard a UFO and her discussion with the "aliens" !)

THE HYPNOSIS REGRESSION INTERVIEW, OCTOBER 4th 1989, (c) UFORIC.

ABRIEVIATIONS : (L) Lorne Goldfader. (H) Helen Williams. (A) Alvina Scott.

(L) What was the childrens reaction to you ? (A) Sort of said that I didn't feel that they belonged to me. (L) They were sad ? (A) Yes. (L) What do you estimate their age was ? (A) Well I guess you would call them children, they were about four feet tall. (L) Was there an intelligence coming from them, telepathy ? (A) There was a telepathy. (L) Were you talking with them ? (A) Mind to

mind yes. (L) Can you give me the gist of the conversation ? (A) Well just that they wanted me to teach them everything that I knew to educate them. (L) Do you recall discussing things with them along those lines ? (A) No, I refused to do it. (L) You refused to do it ! (A) Yes. (L) Can you explain why ? (A) Well I thought the whole situation was ridiculous. (L) So they didn't force you to do anything, like retrieve information from you by force ? (A) No. (helen,) (H) If they wanted to come down at a future date, did they say anything like that, like they would come if you agreed ? (A) No. (H) Then you said that another one came to you ? (A) Well that was in 1987, that was the tall being. (H) So he has grown up already, that's from your egg in four days ? (A) Yes, he was in adult form. (L) Did he tell you his name ? (A) Not that I remember. (L) Do you have any names for these beings ?



(A) Not that I can remember. (L) But you gave me the name of the race. (A) Oh the H.O.O.V.A.S. those were the doctors. (H) There were no more children, just the three ? (A) That's all yes. (L) OK, now this child that grew in four days, was it a "he" ? (A) It was a he. (L) Did he look different than the twins ? (A) Yes. (L) How ? (A) Well it seemed to me like he had skin like ours, and he was seven feet tall. The only difference was the bushy eyebrows 'right across. (L) May I ask what is your purpose, I mean, this is a very difficult thing to do, (comment, for her to appear on t.v. in shadow with her voice electronically distorted which we later did). What is your motivation ?

(A) Well I feel that it is time for this information to come out I don't know why. I just feel that the Government has too long kept everything under wraps. They (the aliens), want to live amongst us. They want to share what they know. (L) Did they mention to you at any time why there's a cover up by our Government, did you talk along those lines ? Why they didn't land openly ? Why they had to do everything in secret ? (A) I don't really know, but I know there is a fear attached there. (L) From who ? (A) Us. (L) I see, are they afraid of us ? (A) Well I think the fear is equal on both sides. (L) Did you get the feeling that they are from a distant physical planet, or another dimension ? (A) It's a combination of both, other planets as well as other dimensions. (L) But the Hoova, where are they from, another planet, or from another dimension ? (A) From another planet in another galaxy.

(Editor's note. At this point Lorne Goldfader discusses with Alvina 'Implants', in which Alvina mentioned that she had a "strange mark" down below. I now continue). (L) Have you mentioned your UFO experiences to your doctor ? No I haven't mentioned it to him at all. In December of 1986, I went for an ultrasound, because I was again having kidney pain, and it showed on the ultrasound 'to me' what seemed like a metal clip inside the kidney, but ohhhh (suddenly remembers), "they" told me that I would pass whatever it was. It took me six weeks to pass, I just remembered that now. (L) Who told you ? (A) The Hoovas, they implanted it there, they said that it

would pass through my urinary bladder. (H) And did you see it come out ? (A) I didn't see it come out, but I sure felt it. (L) There was a little object like a tie clip did you say ? (A) Yeah, the size of a little tie clip. (L) And it was in the kidney ? (A) It was in the kidney. (L) And you think it was for what ? (A) To ease the kidney pain they said. (L) This was a metal object do you think ? (A) Yes, that's what I was told by the technicians at the ultrasound place, it was a little object. (H) On ultrasound, you saw exactly the shape of it ? What did it look like ? (A) It was like a little "C", a quarter of an inch, very tiny. (L) Did any of the doctors comment when they looked at it ? (A) He said I'm not sure what that little thing is.



(Editor's note. At this point the witness went on to relate a strange 'ringing' noise that she experienced in her ears which she felt had something to do with them (the aliens !) And she also discussed with Lorne that the aliens told her not to eat meat ! I continue). (L) Would I be correct, or incorrect, in saying that the 'Hoova' were intermediaries, or that they had a certain function to perform between races ? (A) I think you'd be correct. I feel that they were working in conjunction with a lot of other races. (L) For something beneficial ? (A) Yes (fear in her voice) to 'help themselves'. (L) To help themselves what ? (A) I feel what's going on down here, on the Earth, this negativity, jealousy and all this stuff, is affecting how the rest of the universe is, I think that what we are doing down here, is affecting the whole universe. (L) You said they are 'helping themselves', are they dying for example ? (A) I feel something has happened with their own races, not the fact that they are dying, but the fact that they are over compensated in different areas with their sexual nature, it seems to me as though they don't have genitals anymore.

(H) Atrophied you mean, dwindled ? (A) Yes, and that the only way that they can recultivate their kind is by coming to our race. (L) When you were communicating with these beings, how superior in intelligence did you feel they were if you can measure it in any human way ? (A) Very very advanced. (Suddenly remembers something, and smiles) I do recall the lady saying something about the cloning, like they can take a cell, of say you or me, and it would be like having eight or ten bodies of you up there. You wear out, or a part of you wears out, and they would take out from the other, a new organ or whatever you need. (H) Instead of getting another donar you always have your own donar ! (A) You always have your own, its you. These things are kept asleep, they don't have an essence, they don't have a spark of awareness, they are kept asleep. (Editor's note. At this point, Alvina went on to describe how these bodies were kept, she said they were kept in vats, nude, and with some form of fluid moving around the bodies. There were rows upon rows of these vats, which were made of what looked like clear glass or perspex. Other points were raised, but I'll now move on

and state that in our next issue, (May-June), I'll reprint Lorne's second interview with Alvina (January 30th 1990), in which a much more alarming picture developed, and concerned Alvina witnessing during a further abduction, rows of male and females on tables in which sperm and ova samples were being removed from their bodies.

REFLECTING ON THE NEAR DEATH EXPERIENCE,

Doesn't it seem remarkable that as we approach the later years of the 20th century, a whole batch of so called psychic phenomena are coming to the forefront of the media and public attention? Remarkable also because of the gross ignorance shown by many journalists, so called intellectuals and other experts from psychologists to theologians, who blatantly destroy all matters psychic along with other ideas which don't fit into their narrow thinking. Perhaps this is harsh, but the fact is these people should know better. A true scientist will put his head on the block and accept the evidence that is in front of him regardless of the establishment. It is the search for truth which is at the forefront of scientific endeavour, however unsavoury to current thinking that truth may be. A typical example is the near death experience.

It is a phenomena which goes way back in recorded history and is experienced throughout the world in all cultures and religions. It was known in ancient Egypt, Mediaeval England, and in the ancient Americas. It becomes logical to assume that if at death the soul or etheric body dissociates with the physical body, why then can this not occur in certain circumstances prior to total physical death? We may not yet understand the exact relationship between the spirit body and the physical, but we do know that it is invisible, and that most probably it is vibrating at a much higher frequency than its physical counterpart.

It is reasonable to assume that any severe problems either physical or emotional, may act as a trigger to allow temporary dissociation of the two bodies. NDE's have been reported from attempted suicides, (such experiences tend to alter their conceptions of death rather radically!) Patients who have been severely ill, and patients who have collapsed or have under-

gone the administration of a general anaesthetic. Indeed, working in the field of healthcare, I have been fortunate to hear many such accounts first hand. Perhaps a number of things can be concluded from this before we consider the views of the wreckers. The NDE may not actually be a near death event, but a crisis event leading to the temporary dissociation of the spiritual and physical body. Whatever cause, it is justifiable to keep the name as the majority of cases are indeed near death. The event is universal and for this reason research must continue into its mechanism.

It would not be too far off the mark to conclude that current near death research is one of the most promising areas in substantiating claims of survival beyond death being explored today. But why, if this event has been known of for so long, has it not been proved? The answer, I feel, lies like a great many others in the capacity of today's technological advances to confirm what superstition and intuition has been saying for aeons. The work of Raymond Moody, Kenneth Ring and others, has provided us with the most comprehensive accounts of these experiences ever documented. Moody is a cardiologist in a highly specialised and exacting branch of medicine. These physicians are used to sudden death, they see it every day.

There are also experts on resuscitation techniques, and it is because we are becoming ever more successful at resuscitation, that we can effectively bring people back from what would only a few years ago be certain death. It is these people who tell us such remarkable tales of separation from the physical body; of experiencing a separate consciousness; of seeing a bright light; hearing voices, music, and seeing 'so called dead loved ones'. I think it is time to see what the wreckers can tell us. These are the people (many of whom are doctors and other health professionals) who are always ready to give us rational alternative explanations for this phenomena like:

"The near death experience, while interesting, does not seem to be connected to anything mystical or psychic. It is a normal body defence mechanism towards an overwhelming physical or mental event".

They conclude that this phenomena can be caused by chemicals released by the body during crisis; endorphins and other such chemicals which both help pain and develop a sense of well being. Hearing too becomes acute at this time because it is the last of the senses to go during anaesthetic induction, they say, and suggest this may well account for the auditory hallucinations experienced. Separation from the body can seem to occur when consciousness is being lost. The oxygen deprivation often causes visual problems and can create the impression of a receding visual field, thereby creating the much spoken of tunnel, as well as flashing lights.

Now in fairness, all of these events do occur, and the case is well put. There are however, various flaws in the argument. For example.

(1) Up to 45% of people who are near to death, or in severe crisis, report a core experience of this sort. This is a vast number, so why do we not undertake a much larger research effort than in the past? After all, not all of them can be subject to wild imagination.

(2) It is universal and cross cultural. Religion too does not matter. It happens in children, and they too describe similar experiences.

(3) Oxygen deprivation may not account for this phenomena, Cases are documented where patients have remained fully oxygenated throughout treatment and have still reported the event.

(4) Separation from the physical body seems to occur. How else could people report, in detail, what is taking place in the operating theatre during resuscitation, or at the scene of an accident if this was not so? Lack of oxygen resulting in tunnel vision and sinking feelings should result in fairly rapid loss of consciousness. One would not expect to suddenly view events in detail outside of the body, and indeed as in some cases, suspended above it!

(5) Dr Kubler Ross, a well respected physician and psychiatrist, is an expert on death and dying(Editor's note. She is indeed. I attended a lecture by Dr Ross held in a hospital in Edinburgh a few years back, and fascinating it was too). She is a pioneer in the care of dying people, and is not afraid to express her views on the existence of an afterlife. She knows this exists and relates the case of a blind patient having a NDE and actually being able to 'see' what was going on around her, only to revert to her blind state once she returned to the physical body. Imagination, wishful thinking, or actual out of body experience? Decide for yourself.

The fact remains that the establishment may be very uncomfortable with the logical reasoning behind these events. It is in fact just another nail in their coffin, (if you forgive the pun!) Research needs to be conducted in a number of areas. What, for instance is the experience of so many dying patients? Evidence suggests that the dying person becomes more susceptible to, and conscious of, sensory events beyond our normal senses. There are of course ethical issues in research of this nature. Likewise for those of you who have seen the film 'Flatliners', I wouldn't advocate self induced cardiac arrest in order to experience the event!

The fact that such events and experiences are gaining greater public exposure, can only be a good thing. Raymond Moody's book 'Life After Life' was a phenomenal best seller; and the film 'Ghost' likewise drew large audiences. I am not saying here we have proved anything, but I am saying that we are on the brink of an exciting time for survival research. To the avid researcher or interested amateur, there is now amassing a wealth of diverse evidence from separate but interconnecting backgrounds. Underpinning all of this are the latest scientific discoveries in relation to the organisation

and make up of our physical, observable and invisible universe. Developments in electronics and visual communication are producing products ever more reliable and sensitive. The electromagnetic spectrum is being probed, and discoveries are coming to light in relation to electronic voice communication (EVP) with the 'so called dead'. This is now being developed, not only with audio tape, but with video evidence as well. The growth of physical mediumship is beginning once again, but this time we shall obtain solid evidence. Evidence on video which will not be dismissed so easily. At present these areas of investigation, like those of the near death experience, remain in their infancy, but ground is being gained every day.

If people are willing to make an effort to look around them for the evidence, they will see that it lies at our feet in abundance. If the evidence for survival after death were presented as evidence in a court of law, our case would have been proved long ago, (Editor's note, what an understatement that last sentence is!) We have to hit the sceptics with all that we have got. If your evidence is solid, if you can demonstrate and replicate your work, (and this is what is required, replication, not once, but time and time again) then you should not be afraid of your conclusions. This may seem very rigid, all a little scientific, but we have to meet challenges in a scientific way if we are to win through to a majority of intellectuals. It is no longer sufficient to say we have had proof, we must demonstrate the reality of it!

VOICES FROM THE VOID

(Editor's note. The electronic voice phenomena which was briefly mentioned in our last article leads us nicely into this actual subject as our next article explains).

Just over 20 years ago, a new phenomenon erupted on to the occult scene when Fredrich Juergenson, a film producer from Sweden, was out in the country-side recording bird sounds for one of his productions. On playing the tape back he was amazed to hear many voices, all speaking in different languages. In the jumble however, some of the voices were audible, and one in Norwegian was saying, "Friedrich, you are being watched". At first Juergenson kept his discovery quiet, partly in order to research the matter further, and partly for fear of being ridiculed. In 1963 he made his findings public, and created a world wide interest. One of the people

who approached him was the Latvian psychologist Konstantin Raudive and together they made many tape recordings that seemed to confirm voices from an unknown source. Raudive continued experimenting alone, and during the next few years collected over 75,00 recordings of voices and became largely associated with the discovery of the phenomenon. Some of the voices were clear enough for research to be carried out into what they were saying, and many proved to be absolutely correct, seemingly coming from dead people.

But why did the voices keep changing language, going from Dutch to Spanish to Italian all in one sentence? Other theories were put forward, including one that the voices were from outer space and were being sent by an intelligence that had been monitoring our broadcasts. In 1971 Raudive published 'Breakthrough', a book about his findings. He died three years later. One of the biggest arguments against EVP, (electronic voicephenomena), was that the tapes might have been picking up stray radio signals. But this idea was knocked on the head when experiments were performed inside a specially screened room, a Faraday Cage, which prevented any random radio or television signals entering it. The experiments were 100% successful with many prominent witnesses being present.

Other speculations were taken, including ensuring that the tapes were absolutely clean before use. Some of the voices were so precise about certain things, that there was little doubt they were aimed directly at the people taking part in the experiments. On one occasion, Raudive was drinking wine with a tape running, and on playing it back, a voice in a mixture of German, English, Spanish, and Swedish, said, "Good evening to you, I wish to drink of your wine". Linguistic experts agreed that the languages used were perfect, and that it was very hard for one person to switch into so many different tongues in one sentence. They had to conclude, "They are probably genuine."


These voices are not picked up on elaborate equipment, but on ordinary reel to reel and cassette recorders. The only problem is differentiating between ghost voices and randomly received radio signals. I used to play an electric guitar through a small amplifier, and often picked up police messages through the speaker. CB radio sets on the AM frequency, cause drastic interference at times too, so a very level headed approach should be taken when playing back. Why not experiment for yourself?

Leave a cassette tape recorder on RECORD in a quiet room or out of doors for about half an hour. An external microphone works better than the internal type which sometimes picks up a background buzz. Instead of plugging in a microphone, use a diode, which seems far more receptive, (check polarity with your electrical store). Sit in the area of the tape recorder and concentrate on the tape, thinking of any entitled that might be in the ether.

Various suggestions have been put forward as to why voices are picked up from space life or the deceased, even that the tapes may be picking up thought transmissions from the brains of the living. But presumably space life would have a far more sophisticated way of establishing contact. Wherever the voices come from, they DO COME.

Ever fancied having something named after you or a loved one? something that would live on and be noted well after your demise on Earth? Most people I'm sure, if they were asked, would love to have a ship, a street, or train or numerous other things named after them. These however, are earthly things, so how about something more "spacey", something more "stellar"? Why not have a star named after you, (or a loved one). This believe it or not, can be done for the humble price of £40.00.

The following, is a few paragraphs from the information pack of which I received recently, (details in a moment) it reads thus."The stars are in the sky to be admired and enjoyed by all in their own way. As man has not yet been any further than the moon no Government or organisation can claim sovereignty over any star. (One could not attempt to re-name the streets of London however because various local authorities have jurisdiction over these matters, but the same does not apply to stars, no one has jurisdiction over the sky). The ISR (International Star Registry) makes it quite clear to its customers that they absolutely do not sell any rights of ownership to the star, they merely name it and keep a record of such. No law in any country prevents them from that"

Some of the more famous names to have achieved star status "literally" through this agency, are the following, H.M. Queen Elizabeth The Queen Mother. UFOS AND HOW TO SEE THEM By Jenny Randles. (£14.99 from major book stores or, Anaya publishing, Strode House, 44-50 Osnaburgh Street London, NW1 3ND. Telephone, 071 383 2997.

Well our Jenny has went back to the basic roots of UFOlogy in this work which is heavily illustrated with photographs of alleged UFOs and other such aerial devices. She deals primarily with early historical records of strange lights in the sky, and discusses the early beginnings of 'Flying Saucers', through the Arnold age, onto the alleged alien contacts. What is pleasing about this book, is Jenny's breakdown in regards to the various locations on Earth in which one has a better chance of witnessing a UFO.

CENTRAL SCOTLAND IN GRIP OF U.F.O. WAVE.

Malcolm Robinson

OK, I would need about six ENIGMAS devoted entirely to informing my readers about the biggest UFO wave to hit Scotland in years, which has been occurring in Central Scotland since around November 1992, and indeed is "still occurring as I write" ! Scotland has never seen the likes of it before, (I know I certainly haven't). To say that I've been kept busy with this, would be the biggest understatement in years. But lets start from the beginning.

SOURCE OF REPORT AND INFORMATION.

This case first came to my attention when I heard a news report (November 4th 1992) on Central F.M. a radio station based in the town of Stirling which was informing it's listeners about a spate of UFO sightings in the town of Bonnybridge, (near Falkirk). I quickly got in touch with the person who presented this news item, a miss Jane Barrie who was most helpful. From there I was invited into the Central F.M. studios to discuss the UFO phenomena in general, but not, I must state, the actual events in Bonnybridge as I had yet to become involved with these sightings.

STEPS TAKEN TO OBTAIN RELEVANT INFORMATION.

It was during my talk to listeners of Central F.M. that I made a request for any further witnesses to come forward and get in touch with me. I was then given councillor Billy Buchanan's phone number. Billy had been the main co-ordinator of these UFO reports prior to me becoming involved with this case. (Bonnybridge was Billy's home town). Upon contacting Billy, I found him to be a good source of information as he explained that the situation was developing fast in regards to continuing UFO reports. I then made a number of other enquiries, which quickly showed to me that this case was turning out to have all the hallmarks of a "UFO WAVE". For the record, the Denny area (near Falkirk), had in the past (1982) been a feature of SPI research work in which a whole host of UFO sightings were recorded, including a "repeater witness"

It was decided by both councillor Buchanan and myself that a good step would be to contact the Falkirk Herald to seek out possible further witnesses. Our article in the Herald was published, this brought a flood of phone calls to my home with people relating their own UFO experience.

Local support for UFO claims

MORE people are claiming to have seen UFOs in the Bonnybridge area.

Following last week's Advertiser story on sightings of unidentified flying objects around the village, more people have reported seeing strange lighted crafts in the sky.

Now a team of scientists are urging anyone who has seen anything to contact them.

Malcolm Robinson of the Psychic Phenomena Unit said: "We are taking this whole thing very seriously indeed. I would appeal to anyone who has seen any sort of object to contact me on (0259) 724033."

Local councillor Billy Buchanan has been inundated with calls from people who have had a "close encounter".

"Now that it's out in the open," said Councillor Buchanan, "more people are coming forward. Before, they said nothing for fear of being laughed at".

Councillor Buchanan has also attacked national newspaper reports at the weekend which he said ridiculed the people who had come forward to report the sightings.

Television, radio and national newspaper reporters have been in the area to talk to some of the people who have had sightings.

Councillor Buchanan also had articles featured in the Scottish Sunday Mail, and the Falkirk Advertiser, featured here. Further lines of enquiry that I took to seek out possible solutions to answer these UFO reports were put forward in the direction of both Glasgow and Edinburgh airports. Cumbernauld airport, which is the closest to Bonnybridge, was also contacted. Aircraft do indeed fly over the Bonnybridge region, especially from local Cumbernauld airport, the people I spoke to however, were adamant that what they saw, was most certainly no aircraft or helicopters.

My next line of enquiry was to phone the local police I asked the desk policeman if he was aware of any local people reporting to the police on UFO sightings, he checked his records and informed me that no one had been in touch with this police station to report any such sightings, but if so, he would get in touch with me. As of this writing, no such phone call has been made to me. At home I was still bombarded with continual phone calls, some of which I could clearly see were probable misidentifications of aircraft, however in general, most calls related quite startling sightings, as the following relate.

SOME UFO REPORTS MADE TO SPI.

The witness to this case James Thomson (pseudonym) resides in Bonnybridge and observed the following on Wednesday November 11th 1992. James observed 2 huge bright white lights moving slow towards him (in the Greenhill area of Bonnybridge) estimated at roughly 200 feet up in the sky. The witness then heard a humming noise, he likened it to a washing machine on its final spin. The object then started to move from side to side as it moved above a field. There were small lights on the top of this object, a power surge of noise was also heard. The witness is sure as he can ever be, that this was not an aircraft.

THE SLOGGETT CASE.

The following case generated the most interest during this UFO wave, it concerned the observations of two objects witnessed by a mother, daughter, and son. It was in March 1992, (witnesses can't recall the exact day), that the Sloggett family were walking down the back road from Hallglen to Bonnybridge. During the course of this walk, the time of which was 7pm, Steven Sloggett witnessed in the sky, a large circle of light which he pointed out to the rest of his family. The light then landed nearby, and amazingly they thought

nothing about this and kept on walking. They looked again, and all saw a big blue light 'sitting on the road'. The witnesses described this as a very strong blue light, roughly the size of a basketball. At one stage, all witnesses heard whilst observing this blue object, a distinct rattling or striking of a nearby wire fence bordering a field, (see front cover photo of ENIGMAS). They feel that the rattling of this fence was somehow connected to this intense bright blue ball. SPI have since been to the scene of this incident, and although 8 months since this account, we could not detect any "differing" in the road's surface. The Sloggett family also claim to have heard the following in connection to this sighting. Firstly, a "whirring sound", then the sound of a "door opening" ! then a "howl" ! At this stage the Sloggett family took immense fright, and ran for their lives !

Before I come to the Sloggett family's second sighting which occurred further along this stretch of road, I could speculate and say that this first sighting seems similar to those 'Earth Light Phenomena' that researcher and author, Paul Devereaux writes about. In which owing to movement beneath the Earth's surface, the tectonic strain exerted on rock strata beneath the Earth somehow produces balls of plasma light which can be emitted upwards into the atmosphere, being witnessed by observers and can in this regard, be misconstrued as being a UFO or more fanciful 'Flying Saucer'. Was this the case here ?

The second sighting by the Sloggetts, occurred about a half a mile away from the scene of the first encounter, in which the witnesses claim to have observed an "object" coming out of some trees which apparently illuminated them by flashing some lights at them. I tend to think that owing to the witnesses' fright of the previous incident, this object concealed within these trees on a dirt track road, could well have been a car or large vehicle containing a courting couple trying to scare of the Sloggetts ! For as in the first instance, the Sloggetts again took to their heels.

FURTHER UFO REPORTS.

It was on the 20th of September 1992 that 22 year old Steven Wilson was driving home from Whitecross to Maddiston. He was accompanied on this journey by his friend, 21 year old David Gillespie. During the course of this journey, they both noticed a peculiar object hovering above a field near a housing estate. The object was oval

SIGHTINGS TAKEN 'VERY SERIOUSLY'

U.F.O. expert Malcolm Robinson said his organisation took all sightings "very seriously", but admitted it was often "up against the fear of ridicule".

Mr Robinson is the founder of the Strange Phenomenon Investigations research group.

He said: "We collect evidence from individuals and our hope is that we can help to establish why these things are being seen throughout the skies of the world."

"About ten years ago I did research concerning a number of sightings in the Denny and Bonnybridge areas. I find it surprising that we've now had similar U.F.O. observations in the same locality."

He stressed that "95 out of 100 sightings had natural down-to-earth explanations".

Added Mr Robinson: "But, at the end of the day, there may be people in Falkirk District who are reluctant to come forward to speak about their experiences."

"I'd urge them to get in touch with me by telephoning (0259) 724033."

An R.A.F. Leuchars spokesman said: "The only thing which can hover is a helicopter. I've made inquiries and can't come across anything which fits this description."

A spokesman for Edinburgh Airport was at a loss over what was seen.

He said: "We can't explain the mysterious objects other than helicopters at dawn or dusk."



year old Craig Morrison left his house to run an errand in the town of Lrbert near Falkirk, when he suddenly heard a "whoosing" sound coming from above him in the sky. Upon looking up, he observed three red lights, (rectangular) with a curve structure below them not far above the rooftops of nearby houses. Although the witness couldn't be sure, he felt that the object was circular. After some minutes, the object flew off and was lost to view.

UFO ABOVE ROAD !

It was on the 27th of October 1992, that Patrick Forsyth (pseudonym) was driving accompanied with his two sons aged (11) and (6) towards Stirling. Partick had just left Dunipace and was heading along the A872 doing approximately 45 MPH. Suddenly they observed an object roughly 100 yards in front of them which was circular, two tiered and had a row of green lights encircling the bottom rim of it's structure. Patrick estimates that the object was hovering above the road's surface at a height of between 25, to 40 feet. As they approached ever nearer, Patrick's attention was drawn to a car which had just entered a fog bank which had just "suddenly" appeared from nowhere" ? When Patrick drove through this "fog bank", he looked up and noticed that the object had skidded to it's left as it went through this `instant fog bank". The object was described as jet black with green lights. Six year old David Forsyth looked through the back windscreen of the car and observed the object heading in the direction of Grangemouth very fast.

UFO WITNESSED BY FIRE CREW.

This next account is from the year 1989, which continues to show that UFO activity has been a feature of this area for some years now which seems to intensify on certain dates ? The principle witness is a Mr Robert Muir, (pseudonym) whose occupation at this time was a fireman. Robert had been called out with his colleagues, to attend to a moss fire near some woods which featured in the location a small lake. The location was Gardrum Moss, near the village of Shieldhill. Robert can't recall the exact month in 1989, but remembers the time as being in the early morning, around 00.30am.

This following account was also witnessed by around 15 other fire crew personel. As they attended to the fire, a small red object was observed hovering to the left of two masts in the distance. This

in shape, red in colour, and was sharply defined. They estimated that they observed this strange object for around one and a half minutes. No sound could be heard coming from this object. At 6. 10pm between October and November (witness can't recall exact date). 12

This light then began to come towards the fire engine, then moving at speed, it disappeared to the west. It then reappeared some distance away then sped out of sight within three seconds. A secondary object coloured white, was then observed by all, coming down towards a small lake nearby. It stopped and remained motionless above the surface of this lake at an estimated distance of six feet and at an estimated distance of 20 feet from the fire crew. At this point, all the fire crew were nudging each other asking one another if they too could see this object, and it wasn't their imagination. For this spectacle seemed totally unreal and quite out of the ordinary. Then, to their surprise, the object then `rushed' towards them then turned 90 degrees to their left, and shot away at an incredible rate. With their hair standing up on the backs of their necks, they

With their hair standing up on the back of their neck, they then observed a further object, again coloured white as they were about to leave the scene of this fire. This object moved overhead quite low in a `jerky movement'. It then flew directly overhead the fire crew and moved away at great speed to the west. This concluded the three observations over a five minute period. Having spoken to one of the witnesses to this fascinating spectacle, he is of the strong opinion that the object that hovered above the lake, was under intelligent control, and it gave not only him, but his colleagues the impression that it was observing them. It made them feel nervous hence the hairs standing up on the backs of their necks.

THE BONNYBRIDGE SKYWATCH.

The Bonnybridge UFO sightings were increasing, and as such, were drawing more and more attention further afield. Various newspapers rung me for quotes, followed by Scottish Television's "Scotland Today" Evening News programme. They made arrangements with both councillor Billy Buchanan and myself, and on November the 16th, came out to Bonnybridge to film SPI Interviewing witnesses. That same evening, I was invited back to Glasgow to be interviewed by presenter Viv Lumsden on the Scottish Television roof ! (boy was it cold, no warm studios for me !) Later, a Scottish Television film crew came back to Bonnybridge to film our planned skywatch. This was great, at long last `these T.V. people' were taking these UFO sightings seriously. STV would dearly have loved to have been able to film a UFO which would have given them the `scoop of the century'. I believe that is why they came to film our skywatch.

Joining the SPI skywatch on a bitterly cold night, was Helen Walters, Kevin Rennie, and Glasgow rock group CE IV who as we should know

Shedding light on UFO reports

THIS mystery of a spate of apparent UFOs in Falkirk District could be solved in the New Year.

Experts sifting through dozens of reported sightings in the skies over Bonnybridge, Denny and Falkirk hope to come up with an explanation in the next few weeks.

"Two footcandle fans and three sensors are the best to spot unusual unidentified objects."

Norman Robb and his pal Dan Dobbie were on their way to Brockville last Wednesday when they spotted an odd object.

Grangemouth near Elbow Bay, Mary Gardner and Bruce Barclay witnessed a weird disc-like mass of flashing lights over the

former ice rink in Falkirk on Tuesday. Norman (23), 15 Elving Avenue, Falkirk, was driving down Ochilview Terrace when he saw the huge object overhead.

"It had red and blue lights and one bright horizontal beam. I collected Dan from his house and we watched this thing for a good five minutes," he said.

"I've taken a lot of shots since I obtained seeing it, but I definitely saw something. It wasn't a helicopter or aeroplane."

Dan (17), 86 Ochilview Terrace, Camelon, said: "It was a disc shape, hovering, then moving fast and slow."

The three sensors were going to work when they made their sighting.

"It had yellow, green and orange flashing lights. It was weird," said auxiliary police

Mary (51), 48 Craigholm Road. "It was spherical but had spots sticking out of the sides. It was quite low down and odd," said Rhona (26), Gerald Avenue.

Bruce (42), Spay Court, said: "It certainly didn't look like a plane."

Malcolm Robinson from Strathgordon Investigation said the latest sightings could still have a down-to-earth explanation.

He added: "I hope to be able to shed some light on this at a meeting in the area in January. There's evidence to suggest there is something highly unusual flying in the skies above Bonnybridge and surrounding area."

are committed to serious UFOlogy put into practice through their songs. SPI, along with Scottish Television, (STV), headed off to some lonely moors behind Bonnybridge, (scene of the Sloggett incident) in which the most perfect night sky was in full view, not a cloud to be seen. A sprinkling of stars covered a vast black velvet sky, "perfect conditions". Around 15 to 20 people started our skywatch all looking up to the heavens in hopes of a sighting. The peace was soon shattered however, by a continual stream of cars all heading up to the moors, headlights streaming in all directions, (we hadn't gauged for this mass interest in our skywatch, but I guess that's the power of television for you, this added interest certainly swelled our ranks.

A lot of air traffic was observed during this skywatch, but I'm afraid, no UFOs, most disappointing, but isn't that just usual when Investigators turn up for something like this! This skywatch was shown by Scottish Television the following night, and was put over "fairly". Indeed, STV managed to obtain from a chap in Kircaldy, (near Glenrothes), a camcorder film of which purports to be a UFO which on film looks like a ball of light travelling horizontally across the sky.

BONNYBRIDGE PUBLIC UFO LECTURE.

UFO reports were still coming in thick and fast, indeed former SPI researcher Ron Halliday who has formed his own research group entitled, "Scottish Earth Mysteries", was himself kept busy with UFO reports from the Edinburgh and Lothian Region, so it was clear to see that this UFO Wave was showing the most considerable attention over various parts of Central Scotland. Owing to the immense interest in the Bonnybridge UFO sightings, Councillor Billy Buchanan suggested that SPI should hold a public lecture in Bonnybridge to inform the local residents on what was going on, (by this time even councillor Buchanan had seen a UFO which, he informs me, was totally unlike anything that he has ever seen before, an oval shape object in the night sky with spikes or rods sticking out from underneath it !)

So a date was set, January 31st 1993, and the venue was the plush Norwood Hotel in Bonnybridge. Billy and I both expected a 'fair' turn out owing to the vast publicity generated by both the local and National newspapers, but we were struck dumb and taken aback by the huge volume of people who did attend this lecture. Upwards of 300 people turned up on the night, with many turned away at the door. And it was a free lecture too! Anyway, I firstly gave an overview of the UFO phenomena, which was added to by the use of extracts from UFO videos. I also showed slides, (thanks Philip Mantle) depicting various cases from the annals of UFOlogy, after which I spoke on Scotland's famous 'Livingston Incident', after which I followed on with the Bonnybridge UFO sightings themselves. There were quite a few youngsters in the audience which was nice to see, and come question time, many good points were raised. However, I did experience my very first "hecklers" who now and then shouted out explanations, and laughed out loud at the Antonio Villas Boas case. They

were quickly put in their place however, as members of the audience turned round to them and told them to 'shut the **** up!' Eventually these hecklers were removed from the premises. A black mark on otherwise a very special night. This lecture then was a big success and some local newspapers carried this fact the following week.

Contained within this article, are but some of the UFO reports from the Bonnybridge and surrounding district region. Some of these sightings could well be misidentifications of aircraft, as for the others, well there is at this time a high 'residue' of sightings which seem to defy explanation. These sightings are, at the time of this writing February, still ongoing. SPI are still dedicated into hopefully providing some form of answer, but as we UFOlogists know, this is not always an easy task. But our Investigations are continuing and we will be informing the readers of this Journal in regards to further UFO incidents. Human knowledge depends upon asking questions and if mankind ceases to ask questions in regard to the UFO phenomena then we are doing ourselves no favours. We simply must enquire into the UFO phenomena, for if we don't, then we will always be stuck in primary one.

To those who think that UFOs are a load of balloney, I would say, "get up out of your seat and do some research, talk to these people and you'll soon see that 'something is going on' but that mankind in his limited abilities is still far short of providing an answer. But an answer must be found, for not to enquire is so foolish an attitude and shrinks from the responsibility of mans enquiring mind.

DISMISSING A MYTH...THE CURSE OF JONATHAN BUCK, By Lee Walsh.

Bucksport Cemetary, Bucksport, Maine, USA, September 1989.

The moss covered ground in the cemetery where Jonathan Buck lies was like a deep soft carpet beneath my feet. A gentle fall of many coloured leaves reminded me of a patchwork quilt, readying the ground for winter snows that were bound to come. There is something about an old cemetery one cannot ignore the intense feelings of awe, fear or sadness, wonder or peacefulness that stirs within. I had gone to Buck cemetery in Bucksport Maine that cool september afternoon in 1989 to gather material on the curse and myth surrounding Johnathan Buck, founder of the small town of Bucksport. I left believing that the truth should be known about Johnathan Buck the man.

Truth, even in legend, does not vary in its content. The validity of an unknown remains unchallengeable and indisputable by its consistency and determination to survive even in the spirit world. Though full well knowing that it will never be so, it is time after nearly 200 years, that the curse is laid to rest along with Johnathan Buck.

Standing boldly and silently, facing the traffic on Route I, in the town of Bucksport Maine, is a tall granite monument erected in memory of its founding father Johnathan Buck. On its face is an imperfection in the granite that by no stretch of the imagination appears to be a leg and foot...and therein lies a curse and a legend that will not die! In looking through the 'facts' concerning the Buck curse, there are many discrepancies and conflicting stories surrounding the old tale, depending on the version you have heard or read. In some accounts, the curse is said to have brought forth the image at the gravesite; one uttered by a man, in other accounts it is a woman. There are various reasons given for the curse, as well as other conflicting curses. Johnathan Buck, a harsh Puritanical man, found a Witch in his midst. He ordered her imprisoned and then later hanged.

Ready to be hanged, the supposed Witch uttered this curse, "Johnathan Buck, listen to these words, the last my tongue shall utter. It is the spirit of the only living God which bids me to speak to you. You will soon die, and over your grave they will erect a stone, that all may know the spot where your bones lay and crumble to dust. Upon that stone the imprint of my foot shall appear and for all time, after your accursed face has vanished from the face of the earth, will people from far and near know you murdered a woman!"

I might add here that for many years this 'Witches Leg' has been a grand tourist attraction, selling T. shirts with the imprinted leg and drawing many people to the little town of Bucksport. Perhaps the most degrading account to come out of this legend is that the once upstanding father of Bucksport, (then Buckstown) had an illicit affair with a woman who bore him a hideous deformed son. To cover this scandal, the woman was burned in her own doorway, using the excuse that she was a Witch to cover her demise, hence again, a curse on Johnathan Buck. There are conflicting reports as to the burial site as well as

to where the cursed image of the leg and foot first appeared. In the "Witch's Curse" by James D. Whittemore, Bucksport newspaperman for New England magazine (1902) it says in part, "With a shaft of granite they marked the spot. Where his grave was made in the old town lot and a leg and a foot right through the name of Johnathan Buck, like a badge of shame". A gravestone (at the head of the grave) not the monument on which the image appears is described here. And the large monument carries the name BUCK while the image lies under the name. Early reports mentioned that the gravestone had been worked on or replaced because the image could not be removed by any means, another leg and foot always readily appeared on the replaced gravestone. Other rumours led one to believe that the image appeared on the gravestone shortly after Bucks's burial.

Historians say that the present gravestone is the original one, having never been replaced, and the 'cursed' image only appeared on the Buck monument that was erected 57 years after Johnathan Bucks death. The monument was erected by his grandchildren. There are many conflicting accounts that carry on the myth of the curse of Johnathan Buck and the Witch's leg on his monument. However, unless you search through the old records the curse put on Johnathan Buck by the Witch he condemned to burn, and the proof positive image on his monument is the tourist attraction of Bucksport Maine. In reality, according to the old records, there is no curse and there are no real facts to keep the legend alive any longer. There are some real facts however, and they are as follows.

Although Johnathan Buck was appointed Justice of the Peace in 1784 and later elected to the General Court, he had no authority to condemn anyone to death, either by hanging or burning. Colonel Buck could not have been a Judge at the Salem Witch trials as he was born in 1718 and there is no record of his being a judge while living in the state of Massachusetts. No one was ever burned or hanged in the state of Maine for Witchcraft, that is on record at least! There is no doubt an imperfection in the granite that resembles a leg and foot. However, some say that there is a logical explanation for this. It is not unusual for Blue Hill Granite, from which the monument is made, to have iron flaws, and because of this other shapes have been seen on other stones. Monument makers say that these stains can be scraped off, only to return when the air oxidizes the iron once again. There is nothing in all the many legends and writings of the curse of Johnathan Buck to substantiate one glimmer of truth to any part of the curse. Colonel Buck was, in reality, a shipbuilder and surveyor, the founder of Bucksport in 1762, a veteran of the French-Indian wars, and a Colonel in the revolution. He has much else to his credit including a wife and nine children.

There is generally little harm in perpetuating a good healthy myth mystery or yarn, but this tale that won't "die" is more than that. Members of the Buck family, as well as close friends, have suffered anger and humiliation. Mrs Alice Buck, a direct descendant of Colonel Buck abhors the legend. That September day in 1989 it was quiet in the little cemetery at Bucksport. I had come armed with notepad,

camera tissue paper, crayon and tape recorder. Notes and photos were taken, rubbings of the monument and gravestone were done, and the tape recorder was left running on the gravesite of a relative of William Buck at the far end of the cemetery. I had experimented with 'spirit' communications by tape recorder in the past with quite good results. I must admit that I felt just a little disappointment in knowing there was no real mystery involved here. I picked up the tape recorder that had been silently running on the gravesite, along with a large pine cone, and headed home to Damariscotta, about a 3 hour drive.

Upon returning home, I put the tape in the recorder to listen. Maybe William or Johnathan thought 'they owed me one', for, a long time after the silent drone of 'nothingness' on the tape, there was a very clear sound of blowing wind followed by a long moan! Legend has it that as the curse was spoken, a wind came up out of the west...Well maybe it was just a long and final sigh of relief! After that visit, something kept reminding me of what the Librarian Geraldine Spooner, at the Buck Memorial Library had said. She wished that I would write an article to finally set the record straight concerning their beloved town founder. I told her I would try. I've decided that maybe he will know that I have tried to set the record straight, I think I owe him one. There is the wind and the sigh on my tape to remind me that I never finished the job.

The William Moore Interview. (PART I).

(Editor's note. As promised from our last issue, I now present an extract from an interview that I conducted with American UFOlogist William Moore, co-author with Charles Berlitz on the Philadelphia Experiment. William was also one of the main researchers into the Roswell New Mexico UFO crash of 1947. This interview is from August last year and was conducted at the IUN/BUFORA UFO Congress in Sheffield England).

ABRIEVIATIONS : (MR) Malcolm Robinson. (WM) William Moore.

(MR) William what are your current views on UFO abductions? (WM) I've discussed abductions with some of my friends within the U.S. Intelligence community who are interested in them. Their statements across the board are consistent, that is, they have no reason to believe that they are what they appear to be. They are not what they appear to be!! I have less and less confidence in Bud Hopkins and his methods of investigation and reporting. I think Bud means well, but

he is far too emotionally involved in what he's doing to do critical work on it. I have little respect for Dave Jacobs as an abduction person, but I have great respect for Dave Jacobs as a historian. I

he's in a field that he is over his head in and unqualified to deal with. (MR) Briefly, what are your views on the Gulf Breeze Phenomena and Ed Walters as a witness? (WM) I've tried to stay out of that. I've met Ed briefly across a lunch table with his wife Francis. I've seen the pictures and I've spent many hours with Bruce Macabee, whose a close friend. I just don't have a position on it as far as accepting it or rejecting it, but I am leaning strongly in the direction that it is a hoax, and it is being manipulated by people who are fairly sophisticated in what they are doing. But I don't think they are Government types, I think that it's a private situation. I think that some of the more recent sightings "might" be explained by model aircraft, radio controlled models, large ones, but that's something that I'd like to see further investigated, it's only a hypothesis at this point.

I just can't say that I'm particularly impressed with this case. It's got a lot of publicity because the people associated with it sought to publicise it before they were finished investigating it. (MR) There are many views and theories as to where these UFOs (if they exist in an alien sense) come from, one of them being extra-dimensions. What are your own views on this extra-dimensional theory? (WM) I think whether you use the word extra-dimensional or extra-terrestrial their basically one and the same. Whether they are coming here from somewhere else in time, or somewhere else in space is only a matter of reference. Einstein would tell you that they are one and the same and I would tend to confirm with that, that they are not of our own space time; if one accepts the concept that they are some sort of technology, and that's sufficient whether you want to sit and debate about whether they are coming here from our own future or our own past, or whether they are coming from Zeta Reticulata or Mars.

The point is, we are dealing with something which has every aspect of being a technological phenomena. If it isn't technological, then we are dealing with a natural phenomena which seems to be able to mimic technology, which in itself is fascinating. I think that until we have further answers and are prepared to either give forth with that which has already been learned and is being kept secret, or until the occupants themselves come forward, or the natural phenomenon itself is convincingly and completely explained, the best attitude is not to worry about where they are from, or who they are, or why they are here but rather to begin to get to the bottom of question number one, which is basically, "what are we dealing with"? Once we learn WHAT, then we learn Who, Where, and Why.

(MR) What are your views on the mysterious crop circles which appear chiefly in England each year, have you any theories, ideas,

speculations regarding these crop circles? (WM) In one word, "Fascinating". I don't know what else I can say. I've never seen one it's a phenomenon which is not as common in the U.S. I just plain don't know. I'm not at all impressed by the confessions of those two old foggies Doug and Dave, who said that they made them with a piece of rope, maybe they made a few of them that way, and that's fine, but I don't feel that accounts for all of them. There is a certain sophistication involved here that seems to me, to be beyond their immediate capabilities. Are they extraterrestrial? I don't know, I wish I could answer that in a better fashion except to say that I am fascinated by them.

(MR) Moving on now to the MJ 12 documents, is there any possibility that these documents could be false, (disinformation), and that we are all being led up the garden path? (WM) Of course there is, I'm the first one to say that. I am the first one to say that I was aware of that from the very beginning and took that into account. That's fine if that's what they are, for then we have a story in itself, because whoever created them, if they are false, was extremely knowledgeable in what they were doing, and had access to information which is not in the public domain. They went to a lot of trouble to leak them to an individual who did absolutely nothing with them for several years. If you want to create DISinformation, if you want to mislead your followers, you don't leak the information to a team of investigators whom your certain do absolutely nothing with it until they are done with it, you leak it to the tabloids, you leak it to the blabbermouths, the sensationalists, the ones who will run with it without doing any investigation behind it. You don't leak it to someone who has contacts within the Intelligence community because they may be able to catch you at it. There's too much risk involved.

None of that makes any sense from the standpoint of a surface kind of hoax. There's too much depth with this situation if it is DISinformation, and it could be, then there's a deeper purpose, and a far more lengthy in time purpose in this game. This is a game which is not yet played out, someone is prepared to play it for a long time. You have to remember that these documents were leaked in 1984, nothing was done with them until 1987, no one outside a very small circle of people knew they existed until 1987 to this day, no one has convincingly disproved that one of them is most certainly authentic.

(MR) Between one and ten, what would you say the MJ 12 documents stand at? (WM) You would have to take them as separate documents. For the Eisenhower briefing document, I would give that between 60 and 70% likelihood that they are authentic. For the Truman Memorandum, a one page thing, I give that

between a 20 and 30% likelihood that it's authentic. I really feel that if there is any "phoneyess", then that one stands the best chance of being a fabrication, but a good one. For the Cutler Twinning Memorandum, I give that a 99%. If your going to refute that one, then your going to have to come up with something really convincing, because you could show the typewriter that it was done on other documents, done in the same type. We have other official known to be authentic documents that were done on the same typewriter at the same time in the same office. How are you going to beat that? That's sufficient for a court of law.

(MR) Here in 1992, we are still talking about the Roswell New Mexico crash, now you have done quite a considerable amount of research into this case, do you still feel it holds water and that something extraordinary happened here? (WM) Yes the case certainly holds water, if it didn't, nobody would be talking about it today. Is there still more work to be done? Yes, a great deal more work to be done. Is it easy work? No. All the easy work has been done, what remains is the tough part. The really difficult part of digging out bits and pieces of a puzzle that may mean nothing to you at the time, and may only mean something to you later when you find another piece that fits and suddenly the picture begins to emerge. The biggest question that now remains is "what happened to the wreckage"? And what happened to the field reports that were written concerning the incident at the time. Who wrote them? Where are they? The Government claims they have nothing on file. No record, I'm not convinced that all the people who made those claims are lying. I think they are telling the absolute truth.

If these files exist, they are not in an archive, library, or historical collection, they are in a file cabinet, and they are still classified as active files, and they are NOT accessible through the Freedom Of Information or any other method, until the agency responsible for them makes a statement that they have custody of those files and of the wreckage, and are prepared to make some public statement with regard to they don't exist. Now on the same side of that question, there's the very interesting observation that if this was in fact a weather device, as the Government claim in their cover story, then why not dig up the field reports and release them? What would they have to lose, it would back up their claim that there was nothing to it. The very fact that nothing comes out, not even field reports of a weather device, suggests that it was more than that.

The National Archives system is a zoo, unless a person has had a physical experience with that system and the functioning of it, you cannot imagine the complexity and the confusion of getting anything out of it. They are massively understaffed, they are inundated with paper. The National Archive staff don't even know what they have! The Cutler Twinning memo was found quite by accident while we were searching through 150 boxes of material that had been cleared for release to the public. We didn't know what we would find, as it turned out, there was some UFO related stuff in there! Some was of consequence, and some of less consequence. The Cutler Twinning memo was found, and it didn't appear to belong there.
