

## Radio Original 106fm - 7th July 2007.

SUFOG's PRO Ernie Sears recorded an interview a month or so ago and it was featured in the radios 'Sixty years of UFO's' and Roswell. The show also featured interviews with Nick Pope and Capt. ## Atherfield, August 1976...

This is more of a latent sighting, in that the evidence occurred on a photograph after the experience.

In 1976 I was living with my mother, grandmother and two foreign students at the Coastguard station cottages at Atherfield, mid to south west of the Isle of Wight. An isolated place with a wide cliff and long open beaches often uninhabited even at the height of summer.

One August day, myself, Attila the mum (a quite assertive female parent), Lawrence a Chinese boy, Amrut a British Indian boy and Bill a Cockney friend went to the beach for an afternoons picnic and swim.

We had been swimming quite a lot, and came back to the sand to rest, when mother spotted a substantial plank of wood floating about twenty five feet out in the sea, which she fancied some repair work in the garden, and asked if any one of us would go back out and get it.

There was, suddenly, a deep sensation of trepidation about this, from all of us. Mother was not willing to go herself. Lawrence, formerly a junior officer in the Singaporian army, also did not want to go, Armut, a cool, confident mathematician and logistician, again reluctant and Bill, a plucky Cockney, also ex-military, seemed just as nervous.

I am bound to add that I felt a sense of foreboding myself, although even at the time, I did feel that it might have arisen from influences around me, from the others. Yet the sea itself had when we swam a modest chop, with waves of about two feet high hitting the shore, and it had now, since the plank bubbled up, become almost mirror calm.

That in itself is nothing odd, there was hardly a cloud in the sky, which was deep blue and sunny, very hot, and time and tides do make sudden changes on channel-fronting beaches.

It was a nice-looking plank, clean and cut straight, a four by two with many uses, and I an no coward so, I tied my shirt up around my waist and kept my fedora on against the sun, and strode into the sea.

The deeper I went and the closer I got to it, the more nervous and trepidations I felt, as if there might be something underneath it. It was entirely irrational, and I dismissed the feeling and carried on. But I felt a great relief once I had acquired the plank and begun for shore, again, and also my vanity told me that I perhaps looked quite romantic in the role, so I asked mother to take a photograph.

She took two, on a standard 135 roll of film, colour, instamatic, a not very fancy camera. It was when a couple of weeks later we got the film back, that we saw what was in the sky, above and to my righting the midst of all the blue, a dark dot, which studied under a magnifying glass looked like a UFO. It was in both shots and also on the negative, and the lens, inspected, showed no faults or blemish.

The saucer-shaped object had a dome top with approximately four dark oblong portals in it, and was otherwise a golden-black or brass colour. If you

happen to have a copy of the 1980 issue 'The Alien World', (Orbis Publications, London, 1980-83 Vol. 1 of the Unexplained), then on Page 43, The Meier case, you will find a list and illustration of the so-called Pleiadean spacecraft. Our one corresponds to either type 1 or Type 5, possibly Type 2. But therein the coloration is bluish.

Our modest beach party continued for about two hours after the plank incident, but nobody chose to go back in the water. That sense of being watched also continued, with our party becoming even more guarded about their words. That I recall, was strange and unusual, as we were all quite relaxed with one-another with no reason to feel that way. We did all share that sense of some intrusion, but wanted not to discuss it.


**P110...** How anyone can (except \_\_\_\_\_ or at first or last appearance \_\_\_\_\_ )...

## UK UFO Reports...

### The Norwich Evening News - Norfolk... 26<sup>th</sup> June 2007... UFO Sighting Over Norwich...

It could be proof there really are little green men out there - or it could just be a close encounter with something far less alien.

A couple spotted five round orange objects moving silently across the skies over the city on Saturday night in one of the first UFO sightings this year.

Liam King, who was visiting Norwich from Colchester with his girlfriend, spotted the glowing orbs as he was walking along St Giles' Street, Upper St Giles' Street and Earlham Road at 10.35 pm.

Mr King and his girlfriend were walking back to their hotel on Earlham Road when they saw the mystery objects.

He said: "When we first saw the lights we were walking west up St Giles Street where it was reasonably quiet - and quiet enough to hear that the objects were not emitting any sound.

"Just as we lost the first two behind the roofs of the buildings on Upper St Giles Street we saw a third travelling in the same direction, then a fourth and a fifth.

"We were able to view the fifth light more clearly and were able to see that the light was flying between us and the nearest cloud."

Another man, who also saw the UFOs but did not want to be named, said: "It was amazing - there were six fireballs in the sky, one was much brighter than the others. I took pictures on my camera but they've come out as white fuzzy blobs. When you zoom in it looks like a spiral in spirals. I watched and they all started disappearing, then, this sounds crazy, but one shot into the other one at a speed far faster than any plane could go. And then they shot into space. I feel silly saying it - but what I saw was not normal."

The Norfolk UFO Society confirmed Mr King's description is a very common sighting of an unidentified object.

John Sayer, 54, from the organisation said: "Orange is quite a common description and so are balls of light.

"It seems the Norwich area is a hot spot for UFO activity - a lot aren't reported, but the city has one of the highest number of sightings."

Mr Sayer of Stratton Strawless had around six reports of sightings in the city during the autumn months last year.

Spotters of unidentified flying objects over Hellesdon saw a black triangular craft above Low Road on August 23.

Last week, a pilot and passengers crossing the Channel Islands spotted two large yellow cigar-like objects in the sky.

The objects were thought to be a mile long and the sightings have sparked interest in the eternal question of whether UFOs exist.

Those who believe they have seen an unidentified flying object can report it to the Norfolk UFO Society, but the Ministry of Defence also keeps recordings from across the country.

The MOD reports at the end of 2006 state Norfolk had a similar sighting in East Dereham on May 20 last year where "Orange lights were seen. They appeared to be in formation and travelling slowly."

### Roswell Marks 60th Anniversary Of 'UFO Crash'...

At least 35,000 skygazers descended on the town of Roswell at the weekend to mark the 60th anniversary of the purported flying saucer crash on a ranch.

Participants filled hotel rooms and nearly doubled the south-eastern New Mexico town's population for the Amazing Roswell festival.

The event programme included live concerts (one headlined by a band with a computer-generated "alien" drummer), costume contests, a Main Street parade and lectures pondering everything from body snatchers to "What Does NASA Really Know?"

The festival emerged in the 1990s to generate debate about the purported flying saucer crash in July 1947 which the government says was a top-secret weather balloon.

Believers in the Roswell Incident say the government is conspiring to hide the truth about the events of that day and, more broadly, the existence of extraterrestrial life.

Al Dooley, 59, of Seattle, said he was not sure what happened, but came to the festival to learn more. He was nestled into a seat at a convention center auditorium, eager to hear a talk on "UFO Files from the UK and Government Surveillance of Ufologists".

Although he's not certain whether an alien craft crashed here, he might have seen one himself in

1968 or 1969, he said. His wife, Nancy, sat nearby, visibly less interested. She was waiting for the festival to be over so the couple could move on to the next leg of their vacation in Sedona, Arizona.

The city's convention centre was swarming with vendors hawking trinkets and dolls, photo ops with costumed aliens, psychic readings and a kit to test whether your neighbour or boss is from outer space. Many peddled their books, DVDs or artwork of all things otherworldly.

Chase Masterson, an actress, was signing autographs for fans who remembered her role as Leeta in episodes of Star Trek: Deep Space Nine.

"I am having a very interesting time exploring the theories that are set forth here," she said. "Some are completely outrageous but some are very intriguing."

The festival was organised for the first time by the city of Roswell. Mayor Sam LaGrone said he was surprised by the turnout - and the economic boost it would give the city. "I've never seen so many cars in town," he said.

#### ICONIC STORY

THE Roswell UFO Incident involved the recovery of materials which have since become the subject of intense speculation.

The government maintains that what was recovered was a top-secret research balloon that had crashed. However, many UFO theorists believe the wreckage was of a crashed alien craft and that the military covered up its recovery. The incident has turned into a widely-recognised and referenced pop culture phenomenon.

My wife and I moved to Roswell in 1966. I'd been working at Stanford and was invited to take over the position of Chaves County librarian (which included services to Roswell, the largest city in the county). My mission was to bring library services up to date (we had an inadequate 1912 Carnegie building, serious staffing and funding issues, and almost no Spanish language materials despite a large Latino population).

There was almost no awareness (or interest) about the "aliens" then (although they had supposedly landed almost 20 years earlier). There was one scary factor, however: the town had built its high school underground in anticipation of nuclear risks (you may remember that experiments were being done on the nearby Arizona high deserts).

We settled in, bought a home, became involved with little theatre, etc., - and I found that there was lots of interest in things Scottish. I put on a Burns night and did the address to the haggis to a huge crowd. With that endorsement I decided to invite other poets to "do their thing." Suddenly I had the Daughters of the American Revolution accusing me of being un-American and un-Godly; they didn't like "foreign" stuff - especially if it used Spanish language (remember, this was New Mexico!) - and they especially didn't like

anything by poets who were still alive! Suddenly my efforts to get funding for the library were threatened (you can read all about it in my book RUNNING A MESSAGE PARLOR). My wife and I received anonymous threats, and the John Birch Society paid me a visit.

But - to make a long story short - there was a sudden new crisis in town when rumours of the closure of the town's busy air force base started to circulate. There were efforts to run me out of town and to close the town's only bookshop (because it polluted lone cowboys' minds by selling them PLAYBOY to take with them on the range). But the biggest concern was about how the town would survive economically after the base closed.

The bookseller closed down, and my wife and I had to give our home to the bank; lots of others joined us in leaving. But there was a sense of hope: the mythology surrounding the flying saucer reports could easily be hyped into new hope for a financial future. It didn't matter that folks like me and my wife - and like the native Spanish speaking population - were the only aliens that had been seen around there.

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**The Hertfordshire Mercury – Hertford...  
20th July 2007...  
Orange Lights Spark Big UFO Mystery...**

Sky watchers across the Mercury patch thought the little green men were invading this week.

Mass UFO sightings had alien watchers' antennae twitching.

Several people reported seeing orange orbs moving silently over Ware and Stanstead Abbots at the weekend.

Chris Hollis, news DJ for Heartbeat FM, said: "We have had loads of calls from people who have spotted the UFOs. I saw them too and thought that the aliens were about to land. Maybe the Mercury can find out what these lights were."

Several people reported the lights on community website Ware Online.

Former Chauncy School governor Pat Horridge said: "They came up from the horizon and slowly climbed in height. The light output was orange and seemed to twinkle like fire, but was consistent throughout the time visible."

"There didn't seem to be any sort of order to them, just a large cluster that drifted apart - very weird."

A likely explanation is that the glowing orange lights were nothing more than paper lanterns - the latest craze for summer parties and barbecues.

Powered by tea lights, they work like small hot-air balloons. Originally used in China as a way of sending messages to the heavens, the idea has caught on here.

'Wishes in the Sky' are little hot-air balloons made of orange paper to give the gentle orange glow as they float.

### Do UFOs Really Exist?

IT'S the weird and wonderful place where the men in grey suits from Whitehall meet the little green men from Mars.

The Ministry of Defence has for the first time opened its real-life 'X Files', detailing how its experts have examined photographs of UFOs hovering over the UK.

While the images range from the baffling to the risible, there is no doubting the seriousness that officials reserve for the issue of extraterrestrial life.

Correspondence between the MoD and members of the public who report sightings of strange objects reveals that Whitehall mandarins remain "totally open-minded" about the existence of UFOs.

The letters - obtained by Scotland on Sunday through the Freedom of Information Act - confirm that the MoD has a procedure of scrambling fighter planes to confront any unidentified craft or object that enters UK airspace.

However, there are hints that at least some strange objects seen in the sky are of a distinctly terrestrial provenance.

In one letter, officials admit that military helicopters carry out low-flying combat training missions across Britain, and apologise for any alarm they may have caused.

The MoD has confirmed it receives more than 100 reports of UFO sightings every year, many of which come from Scotland.

Last year alone, the Ministry was sent five sets of photographs and videos purporting to show UFO activity.

One was sent by a concerned resident who last March reported seeing silent super fast "triangular craft" and other strange objects in the skies above the south of England.

He enclosed a picture that appears to show a ball of light moving at speed across the sky with an illuminated trail in its wake.

A lengthy official response from the MoD's Directorate of Air Staff is at pains to reassure the individual.

It states: "We remain totally open-minded, but to date we know of no evidence which substantiates the existence of these alleged phenomena.

"The MoD examines any reports of unidentified flying objects it receives, solely to establish whether what was seen might have some defence significance; namely whether there is any evidence that the UK's airspace might have been compromised by hostile or unauthorised air activity."

The letter claims the Ministry could not justify spending public money on being an "aerial identification service", but stresses that every precaution is taken to protect the integrity of UK airspace.

It adds: "I should inform you that low-flying training takes place throughout the UK.

"In the event of conflict, helicopters are vulnerable to ground fire, and one of the vital skills that must be acquired by pilots is flying as closely as possible to the nap of the earth so that the aircraft is shielded and camouflaged by the features of the terrain.

"This type of training is spread as thinly as possible throughout the UK, so as not to concentrate activity over one area. I am sorry if this training has caused disturbance to

you."

The MoD also received a succession of images of objects in the sky above Portsmouth harbour last July.

And in one decidedly eccentric letter last May, a concerned citizen warns the MoD that she and her husband are being menaced by invisible craft, the grey alien inhabitants of which have already abducted her in the past to "extract her DNA".

To support her case, she enclosed a photograph of an all-too-visible object (possibly a Frisbee or a satellite dish) "hovering" over a church.

In an impeccably polite response, MoD officials come to the sober conclusion that: "With regard to your particular observations, we are satisfied that there is no corroborating evidence to suggest that the UK's airspace has been breached by unauthorised aircraft."

In another response to an individual who claimed to have provided film evidence of UFO activity over the Clyde in Glasgow last year, an official states frankly: "I have viewed your video and I am content that it contains nothing of defence concern."

The MoD confirmed that in 2006 it received more than 100 reports of UFO sightings, including 12 from Scotland.

The previous year around 150 sightings were reported, with again a dozen coming from north of the Border. These included six reported sightings on the same day (September 14, 2005) in Fife and Perthshire of "bright white lights" in the sky.

The unidentified objects were sighted in Lochgelly, Glenrothes, Crieff, Letham, Blairgowrie and Kinross.

Nick Pope, who headed the MoD's UFO Project between 1991 and 1994, confirmed that reported sightings were taken extremely seriously.

"The MoD wants to know everything flying in the UK's air-defence range and investigate all sightings," he said.

Pope revealed that 95% of UFO reports turned out to either have obvious explanations or to be so vague that any investigation was impossible.

"The remaining 5% of cases were pretty interesting and remained unexplained even after a very thorough explanation. It doesn't prove that these objects were extraterrestrial, but you can't rule any option out."

The former MoD investigator even claimed that officials tried to copy the advanced technology of unidentified vehicles.

"A number of reports were of silent triangular aircraft travelling at considerable speed," he said. "These and some other reports suggested some sort of propulsion system we would be extremely interested in.

"A lot of the serious UFO investigation was aimed at trying to ascertain things such as the aerodynamics of some of the UFOs, the avionics and the propulsion systems.

"We wanted to know if there was anything that we might learn from, regardless of what the source of these UFOs is."

Regarding 'Green Men Myth'... (Cornwallis column, Evening Mail, August 7), the following should be noted...

The acronym UFO stands for unidentified flying object not "alien spaceship" and while the vast majority (about 95 per cent) of UFO reports are explainable, the rest are not, a fact conceded by defence ministries throughout the world.

Contrary to the statement that "there is not a scrap, not a shred of evidence for the existence of UFOs", well over 4,000 military and civilian pilots (as well as numerous naval officers, astronauts etc) have reported encounters with unknown flying craft - frequently confirmed by radar - and thousands go unreported owing to military or other professional security restrictions.

In addition, thousands of previously classified intelligence papers (many Top Secret) prove how seriously the subject is taken by officialdom.

As former CIA director Admiral Hillenkoetter stated in 1960: "Behind the scenes, high-ranking air force officers are soberly concerned about the UFOs. But through official secrecy and ridicule, many citizens are led to believe the unknown flying objects are nonsense."

Regarding film/video footage, most can be explained in terms of hoaxes or misidentifications, but certainly not all. As for hardware, plenty exists - including several vehicles recovered prior to the 1947 Roswell incident - though such hardware remains highly classified to this day.

"The classification was, from the outset, above Top Secret, so the vast majority of US officials and politicians - let alone a mere allied minister of defence - were never in the loop," declared former Canadian defence minister Paul Hellyer two years ago.

As to "why do they not reveal themselves?", thousands of witnesses throughout the world - including high-ranking military personnel - have reported encounters with extraterrestrial beings.

Again, probably the majority can be explained, but not all.

Readers may be interested to know that my latest book, *Need to Know: UFOs, the Military and Intelligence* (published in July by Pan Macmillan) reveals all this information in depth.

"I felt like it saw me and then, after about 20 seconds, it shrank and eventually disappeared."


But that wasn't the end of it, as Mr Reed explained: "Twenty minutes later, eight to 10 planes flew over in a uniform line."



Below clouds. Facing south. Bright round light. Conical shape underneath the light. Bright orange / cream. Horizontal flight. Went into cloud going fainter. From direction of ocean village. 10 sec husband saw object. Curved down towards sea. Very bright – than star – lower. View for about 25 secs?

### **SG/13/07...**

Comment: I have 7 pictures of light anomalies taken on 10/08/07 in Wiltshire. The time was 1926 and the lights appeared for about 6 minutes. The

pictures were taken on 2 mobile cameras and the quality is good.

The first light appeared to be a spectrum of light ,oblong shape , which formed into a ball of light. I took pictures of this with both my camera and my wife's.

I assumed that light was reflecting from the sun onto high altitude clouds or possibly reflecting light from the moon.

When at home I inspected the pictures and discovered another bright ball of light ,smaller than the oblong spectrum, appearing to move from the oblong to the left and then upwards.

I thought this was a reflection on the camera but it also appears on the other camera and on one shot has a small branch partially in front of it.

I spent 12 years in the Royal Air Force. I know aircraft. This is not a balloon, helicopter, airplane , weather balloon etc... the pictures speak for themselves.

### **SG/14/07...**

comment: I hope u can help me on the 8/8/2007 I saw a light in the sky it was changing color form red to blue then green and what got my attention that it was not moving like any aircraft that I no of, and last night at about 1:00 am I was looking out of my bedroom window and I saw it again this time I've got 2 witness my son and my wife, the object was in a Southerly position. I live in Andover can u tell me if there have been any other reports of the same thing.

### **SG/15/07...**

My first sighting was on July 18th 2007 at 22:30. The witnesses were myself and my boyfriend. We had not drunk alcohol or consumed drugs of any kind.

My boyfriend was just leaving my house, so I was by the front door looking out over the field in front of my house in the New Forest. I noticed a light moving in a strange way over the horizon. My boyfriend did too...we spotted it independently and thought it's movement very odd. It was moving from side to side and up and down, just above the tree line. I can't help but note that planes rarely fly backwards, yet that's what it seemed to be doing. I tried to get my head round it, assuming that it was flying towards us initially, which might have accounted for its movement throughout the left/right/up/down plane. That theory didn't add up in terms of light and movement as the object got closer. It would have to have been flying sideways to account for it's left-right movement if the main white light had been the headlight of a plane.

The object flew up over the polo field and turned a slow circle round the field in front of the house, about twice the height of the trees above the ground. It was barely audible. A normal plane would have been very loud if that close and that low but I was straining to hear anything. There were lights, a big bright one and several flashing ones in red, white and yellow. The movement of the craft just did not tie up with the way the lights would be if it was a plane. I think the red light was on top and the yellow lights underneath.

Whatever the object was, it was silent, low-flying and very maneuverable. It had a single bright light on the front that shone directly at us both on part of the loop it flew. I don't know of any plane that could have turned in as tight a turning area as this object did, certainly without making a noise. The light was so big and bright, it could not have been a radio plane or lantern.

Our very own SOUTHERN DAILY ECHO came up with a massive weeklong...and longer, eventually...headlining coverage of a formation of "lights" passing over the city of Southampton in JUNE, filmed by a local man, backed by other witnesses. Not surprisingly, they were explained by someone who thought he'd enliven a barbecue with those pesky Chinese lanterns although we've heard that one before, and the lights, which kept in steady formation, at least put a weeklong focus with headlines front paged and articles inside. ALL vanish in seconds. NONE are seen by ANYONE.....such "cloaking" not entirely unknown in UK and foreign parts....means the authorities can blandly deny any official sightings by any means, radar included, as their replies to me show. Recently George Warner has decided to go his own way and I

wish him luck.. the "objects" seem to have moved further away making magnification difficult. FIRST REGISTERED MASSIVE SIGHTING IN PERU, says OVNI'S back page. Photo shows strange blue and white object with "squiggle". Report says formations of white spheres. MAY 07. Thirty forming geometric figures. Lasted for two and a half hours, `filmed by ATV news cameramen. `Tens of people watched.'

## World News & UFO Reports...

### The Vashon-Maury Island Beachcomber - Vashon Island, Washington, USA... 20<sup>th</sup> June 2007... Maury Island's UFO: 60 Years Later, The Mystery Lingers...

Roswell, once just a military base in the New Mexican desert, is known today as the site of the United States' most high-profile and controversial UFO sighting and crash. But few Islanders know that Maury Island was home to the first alleged UFO sighting in U.S. history, and it took place weeks before two crafts fell from the sky in Roswell.

Tomorrow marks the 60th anniversary of the Maury Island Incident, as it was later dubbed in books and newspaper articles. It took place in June 1947, two years after World War II ended. The nation was abuzz with paranoia and suspicion, and it was in this atmosphere that first one, then two, then hundreds of Americans reported seeing strange, unidentifiable, usually saucer-shaped, objects whizzing through the sky.

These were the incidents that triggered UFO hysteria, which gripped the nation for decades and spawned countless movies and books. But it all started with one close encounter. One X file. It all started with Maury Island.

While no one can say for sure what happened that afternoon in the Puget Sound, after cobbling together the various eyewitness, secondary, government and media accounts, a story with a life of its own emerges:

At 2 p.m. on June 21, 1947, Tacoma seaman Harold Dahl was trolling the waters just east of Maury Island, looking for loose logs, which he collected and sold for profit.

"As I looked up from the wheel on my boat I noticed six very large donut-shaped aircraft," Dahl later told one of the investigators of the incident. "I would judge they were about 2,000 feet above the water and almost directly overhead."

He said the ships were 100 feet in diameter, had no "visible signs of propulsion" and made no noise.

One craft wobbled and dipped to about 500 feet, he told investigators. It then spewed what Dahl described as thin sheets of white metal and several tons of hot lava-like rocks or slag.

As the slag rained down on Dahl, his son and his dog, it punched holes in the vessel, burned Dahl's son on the arm and killed the family dog.

Another of the six saucers seemed to come to the assistance of the ship in distress, "jump-starting" it, according to Dahl. Then the crafts took off. Dahl gathered samples of the rocks and the white metal and went home for the night, shaken.

The next morning he had what modern ufologists refer to as the first encounter with a "Man in Black" — an ominous individual who warned Dahl his family would be in danger if he went public with his story, according to Kenn Thomas, who wrote the book "Maury Island UFO." Although Dahl had not yet told anyone about his UFO

sighting, the man in black knew many details of the incident, he later reported. Dahl said he suspected the man was a government official.

Later that day, Dahl told his supervisor Fred Crisman about his UFO sighting. Crisman, dubious, visited Maury and collected his own samples of the slag. He then contacted Ray Palmer, an adventure magazine publisher, to see if Dahl's story was fodder for his magazine.

The next day, three days after Dahl's sighting, UFOs went from obscurity to front-page news. On June 24, 1947, U.S. Forest Service employee and pilot Kenneth Arnold reported seeing nine "saucer-like" objects flying in formation at speeds of up to 1,200 miles per hour near Mount Rainier. Arnold contacted the press immediately, and the tale spread like wildfire. Soon, U.S. media were saturated with reports of Americans spotting UFOs, almost always saucer-shaped. "Flying saucer" became a household term.

Because Arnold had the eye of a highly trained pilot, his story became big news. Dahl's story, however, remained obscure until Arnold was dispatched by Palmer to investigate just what it was Dahl saw off the shores of Maury.

Arnold flew to Tacoma in July 1947 and rented a room in the Winthrop Hotel, where, according to FBI reports, Arnold met with Dahl, decided the sighting was authentic and called two U.S. intelligence officers to tell them the news. The men, Capt. William Davidson and Lt. Frank Brown, became the first two Army officers to investigate UFOs, Arnold said in a book he later wrote.

After Arnold phoned Davidson and Brown on July 31, 1947, they flew to Tacoma within an hour, gathering in Arnold's hotel room where they pored over the details of the incident and collected samples of the slag and white metal, according to Arnold.

The officers' plane was due back the following morning for inaugural Air Force Day ceremonies, marking the separation of the Air Force from the Army. So, although it was after midnight, they returned to their plane, allegedly carrying UFO slag and metal, and headed for Hamilton Air Force Base in California. Twenty minutes into the flight, their engine caught fire, igniting the left wing. The two crew members aboard the plane with Davidson and Brown parachuted to safety. But neither intelligence officer jumped nor radioed distress, according to news reports. Instead, both died when their B-25 plane crashed near Kelso, Wash.

The military promptly sealed off the crash site and cleaned up the rubble from the U.S. Air Force's first accident. But they left some of it behind.

Only a few locals knew the location of the crash, and none investigated it fully, LeFevre said. But in April 2007, now-owner of the site Bob Greear visited it, accompanied by LeFevre and Philip

Lipson, co-directors of the Seattle Museum for the Mysteries.

The three retrieved a blackened, lava-like rock from the site, which now sits in their museum, as well as mangled pieces of the B-25 that went down that night.

Bill Beaty, a research engineer at the University of Washington and a member of the museum's board, analyzed the rock and found that it was "almost certainly an Earth rock." But more analysis should be done before writing the specimen off, he said.

After the fatal accident, the government staunchly denied any classified material had been on board the B-25.

But the media knew the names and mission of the deceased officers before the military released them. An anonymous caller contacted various Washington dailies on July 31 through Aug. 3, 1947. The caller gave such intimate details of the conversations that took place in Arnold's hotel room that Arnold thought the room was bugged. The identity of the caller remains unknown.

While newspapers differed on details, they were in agreement on one thing - the government wasn't telling the whole truth.

The U.S. military cited Dahl and Crisman's signed confession that the Maury Island Incident was a hoax. But upon government questioning, the two said they had only sworn their story was a fabrication to protect their families.

It wasn't until 1979 that the government declassified the FBI files admitting Davidson and Brown had been investigating the Maury Island flying discs at the time of their deaths.

"It didn't start with Roswell. It started here in the Pacific Northwest," LeFevre said of ufology. "People should be aware of that."

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### Voices Newspaper - Didim, Aydin, Turkey...

#### Strange UFO Sightings Over Didim...

Didim became the UFO sighting capital of Turkey when several people reported seeing strange lights in the skies.

The strange yellowish melon-shaped ball was spotted by the Police Academy in Yes, ilkent, while regulars at the Ark Cafe Bar, in Hunters Valley, spotted the same UFO-style lights at about 9.30pm last Saturday night.

Phil and Lorraine Quibell said they spotted the strange lights heading towards them but hundreds of metres off the ground as they walked on the Yes, ilkent road, close to the police academy at about 9.30pm.

They described how the melon-shaped object was moving fast and in a straight line before swerving towards the police academy direction and towards the sea before disappearing over the horizon.

Mr Quibell, aged 52, formerly from Preston, said the object was a bright sun colour at the top but faded to a yellowish-moonlight colour below.

There was no noise coming from it either before or after they had seen it.

He said: 'It was something that I had never experienced

in my life and I am still trying to explain it away rationally 48 hours after we had seen it.

'But both of us have said that we have never seen anything like it in our lives'.

The UFO-sighting ironically comes nearly 60 years to the day when the unidentified flying object phenomena began.

Mr Quibell said: 'There were two guards at the police academy who saw it and they were looking in the air and could not believe it. The object did not have wings or landing lights so it was definitely not a plane.

'It was probably the size of a plane. It is very difficult to explain it. I only wish I had taken my camera with me. I watched the object for what seemed a few minutes but may have been only seconds before it veered away and out to sea'.

Meanwhile, Mark and Alana Weatherall, who were with children Paige and Josh, had been with friends at the Ark Bar when they spotted the bright light over the Yes, ilkent area at about the same time.

Alana said: 'It was like a bright light but nothing like a plane or a helicopter. It seemed to hover for a number of seconds and burn like a white ball of light and then it just faded out altogether'.

Mark added: 'What surprised us was that it seemed to go vertically up from its original position. It was a weird experience but it definitely wasn't a plane. It must have been a UFO'.

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### The Shanghai Daily – China...

#### Pilot's UFO report released after 16 years...

"It's moving very fast to the northeast, spraying fire-like gas and transforming into two objects, a ball and a cube."

It's not a line from a sci-fi movie, but from a tape recording of a conversation between a ground dispatcher and a passenger plane pilot who allegedly chased an unidentified flying object 16 years ago above Shanghai.

The tape, the only known in-flight voice recording of a UFO sighting in China, was released to the public for the first time during a UFO seminar held on Saturday in Shanghai, Beijing Legal Times reported today.

The recording has been kept by Wu Jialu, former senior engineer with the Shanghai Aircraft Design and Research Institute. He said equipment needed to analyze the report wasn't available until now.

"The 26-minute-long tape recording on March 18, 1991, included the pilot detecting the object, following it and eventually, he watched it disappear," said Wu, now director general with a city's UFO research center.

Wu played the taped conversation to the newspaper. The following is a transcript of the conversation:

Airport dispatcher (A): 3603, what did you see?

3603: I took off, flying about seven sea miles (13 kilometers) at the Course 28 degrees. I found an unidentified flying object right at my front. It was three meters to five meters in length. It's red and it looks like it is spraying fire. It's flying to the northeast. I turned slightly to the north and the object was farther and farther from my plane. It's moving fast and suddenly it turned around.

I flew about 20 sea miles (37 kilometers). It is moving southeast. It's flying lower and lower. I turned a little to the west. It turned around suddenly to the north again. It turned black.

It separated into two, one ball on the upper side and one cube below it. The two objects flew northeast for a while and then they turned to the northwest. They climbed up and disappeared. They came out, and disappeared again.

A: I got it.

A: When did you last see the object?

3603: About 6:26 pm at 10 sea miles (18 kilometers) from Wuxi City.

A: Well, what's its location then?

3603: It was right in front of me.

A: 3603, can you estimate its speed?

3603: Its speed, um, the maximum speed... It's difficult to say. It's about 600 kilometers per hour to 700 kilometers per hour. I felt like it's flying at the speed of big planes.

Cui Yilin, a reporter with Shanghai-based Xinmin Evening News, told Beijing Legal Times that he received hundreds of calls from local residents on March 19, 1991, saying they saw a "red fireball" over Shanghai the previous day.

"There were calls from Wusong, Xinzhuang and Bund areas. But the one that really got my attention was from Hongqiao Airport," Cuisaid.

Jin Xin, an on-duty dispatcher at the navigation tower of Hongqiao Airport on March 18, 1991, told Cui that he saw the flying object, which was engulfed by red light.

"I immediately asked a pilot that was about to take off to follow the object," Jin told the newspaper.

Jin gave a tape of the recorded conversation with the pilot to Wu after the incident.

Jin said pilot 3603 was Zhu Zhaoyuan, who flew for Jinan Airlines, which has since been taken over by China Eastern Airlines.

"He was piloting a small passenger plane when he chased the object," Jin said. Zhu was middle-aged and an experienced pilot, Jin added.

Zhu could not be reached for comment, said the report. Liu Yan, a researcher at Purple Mountain Observatory under the Chinese Academy of Sciences, told the newspaper that more than 90 percent of UFO reports were false. "People are easily misled by the reflection of light emitted by planes and believe they see UFO," said Liu.

### UFOs Attacking Ukraine...

Ukraine's political life is no stranger to the unusual and the inexplicable, but if ordinary people tire of intrigues and controversy, they can turn their attention to more celestial, if no more comprehensible phenomena. UFO sightings are up across the country. But in contrast to the politicians, no ufologist claims to have all the answers.

The Zond center for the study of anomalous phenomena claims that Ukraine has seen an increase in UFO activity over recent years. "While in the 1990s we had 10 to 15 reports a year, now their number has increased to 20-30. Most of them are accompanied by photos and videos. Witnesses understand that if they have seen something unusual in the sky they must tell researchers about it," said Artyom Bilyk, the center's learned secretary.

In scientists' view, the increase in reported sightings is explained by the proliferation of technology, as more and more people have access to cameras, video cameras, camera phones and so on. But even controlling for the increase in available technology, the UFO phenomenon is now observed more often than before.

Most sightings come from large cities with large populations, ufologists say. The Crimea is particularly famous for the number of observations, especially in summer time.

But the explanation is simple. Dr. Alexei Perekhod said this is because "there are many disco clubs in the Crimea, which are equipped with laser units. With low cloud cover, the lasers produce mysterious glow overhead." Besides, the seasonal increase of sightings in the Crimea (and some other southern regions) correlates with a seasonal increase in population, as large numbers of holidaymakers arrive for the summer. More people mean more eyes to spot UFOs.

But researchers want more than to merely record an event. Their real ambition is to determine its nature. Current statistics show that about 90% of sightings are of natural phenomena (aircraft, birds, satellites, stars, etc.). Only the remaining 10% are of interest to scientists.

### **UFO - A Threat To National Security?**

Researchers are not joking when they say UFO appearances over Ukraine may threaten its national security. "Such flying machines may well be spying apparatus sent by other countries, or flying test prototypes from within and outside Ukraine," Bilyk said.

In addition, UFOs may pose a direct threat to witnesses' health and safety.

UFOs interacting with the environment sometimes produce distortions in biological life (altering plants and animals), increase radioactivity or electro-magnetic fields, and generate other fields of an unknown nature. Occasionally UFOs leave noticeable environment effects.

### **From The Horse's Mouth...**

Svetlana Shevchenko and her mother Victoria

witnessed a unique event on Easter night 2007. "At about 23:30, from a fifth floor balcony in Kiev, we saw something unusual. Those were certainly not stars, we have never seen anything like that before," said Svetlana. She took a picture of the event, which is now studied with interest by UFO experts.

"They were searchlights or lamps. Two hovered permanently, with one of them directing a pencil beam at the monastery, and the other at Kreshchatik Street. Curiously, the light from the lamps was white yellow, and the beams blue. A third and fourth lamp kept appearing and disappearing," the witness said.

A similar object was seen in Kiev six months earlier, on October 6. A photographic camera registered three luminous spheres in the sky.

#### **UFOs May Change Our Future...**

UFOs often seem to exert emotional effects on people, producing either inexplicable joy and elation, or fear and depression. An interesting case was recorded in the village of Yablunivka, Kiev Region, in 1989. "People who watched a UFO's radiant envelope felt euphoric. They were certainly under a kind of spell, and additionally they were fascinated with the sight," Bilyk said. Aside from natural sense of curiosity, an UFO can suppress human will, "freezing" witnesses in their tracks, or making them take flight in panic. Many of the reported effects of UFOs bear striking similarity to folk-tale descriptions of devils, angels, elves, gnomes, and mythical creatures.

There are many cases of UFO's affecting machinery, especially cars and radio electronics. In 2003, when eleven objects were observed at the Lonzherson beach in Odessa, the witness' quartz watch stopped for an hour and a half. Shortly before that animals had been seen behaving erratically. Bilyk suggested that some instructions should be drawn up for law enforcement agencies and authorities telling how to act in close encounters of the third and fourth kind.

Dr. Perekhod's most memorable sighting was on an expedition to the Sumy Region, where he identified the after effects of a flaming poltergeist. In the effected house objects had spontaneously burst into flame. In the two hours it lasted no less than 17 spontaneous combustions were recorded. In a stack of bed sheets the one to catch fire was that in the middle.

Another interesting case was in the Kiev Region, where investigators found a tree with charred roots growing from a crater lined with a substance resembling old tarmac. "No natural occurrence can have such consequences. And although our expedition ended several months ago, I am still puzzled: How can one explain it all?" the expert said.

UFOs may turn out a much more complex phenomenon than the human mind can imagine. So ufologists urge everyone to look upwards more often. The odds of you witnessing something unusual and inexplicable are great.

### **The Sun-Journal - Lewiston, Maine, USA... 14<sup>th</sup> August 2007... Doctor Says He Saw Odd Lights Over Lewiston...**

LEWISTON - Dr. Barry Chandler has seen the space shuttle in the sky at night, and plenty of meteor showers, and this, he says, was definitely nothing like those.

The Florida man looked up in the sky Friday night at 10:05 p.m., from his mother-in-law's lawn on Marble Street and saw a rough string of 10 to 15 lights travelling together in clusters.

"It was extremely unusual and I'm not prone to calling in things like this," Chandler said Monday.

He, his wife and mother-in-law watched them move from the southern corner of the sky to the north, finally fading from view, after about four minutes.

"They were fairly pulsing. It was like a flame but it wasn't; I can't describe it," Chandler said. The lights reminded him of the flames inside hot air balloons when they take off. They seemed to pulse.

"In Florida, we see meteor showers all the time. Even the space shuttle going up was not the same thing," he said.

Chandler, chief of neonatology at the Miami Children's Hospital, has a summer home in Poland Spring.

"I'm a very left-brained person; I like to be very analytical," he said. "I'm not a kook."

He's sure of what he saw.

Chandler called the National UFO Reporting Center. It hadn't received any other reports. Neither had the National Weather Service in Gray.

Meteorologist Michael Cempa said Friday night was clear. The recent meteor shower, which peaked Sunday, would look like bright streaks across the sky, not steady lights, he said.

The German Web site Heavens Above noted that iridium flares -sun reflecting off satellites - could be seen from Lewiston at 6:14 and 6:23 that night, but nothing later.

A spokesman at Brunswick Naval Air Station said it wasn't anything of theirs. A Hanscom Air Force Base spokeswoman didn't have any information.

Androscoggin County dispatch didn't take any calls reporting strange lights Friday night.

"It sounds strange," said Sheriff Guy Desjardins. "But strange things happen."

The city of Fredericton is proclaiming today as Stanton Friedman Day, an homage to the 73-year-old UFOlogist who has talked and written his way to the top ring of the galaxy of believers who say Earth is being visited by aliens.

Friedman has built himself a reputation as the ultimate authority on flying saucers, alien abductions and the infamous Roswell incident, considered by many to be the definitive UFO event in world history.

This year marks the 60th anniversary of that day near Roswell, N.M., when the U.S. army claimed briefly it had recovered an unidentified flying disc - triggering a flying saucer frenzy that endures to this day.

Although the U.S. military later backtracked, insisting the object was just a fancy weather balloon, that only gave birth to Friedman's other major area of study - the so-called "cosmic Watergate."

Friedman says his personal success owes much to the fact that people have an endless fascination with space and the unknown.

"Can you think of anything that touches more deeply on who we are, where we stand and the mystery and the cover-up?" he says in an interview from his comfortable Fredericton home.

"People are excited because it opens up the universe to wonderful possibilities."

Fredericton Mayor Brad Woodside says Friedman is being honoured not only because of his tireless efforts in spreading the word about UFOs, but also because of his enthusiastic promotion of the city.

"Stanton has lived here for 27 years," Woodside says.

"He's not only a nuclear physicist but also a world-renowned UFOlogist. In just the past few months, he has appeared on Larry King Live, Fox News Live and he appeared on CBS Sunday Morning. He could live anywhere in the world but he has chosen to live in Fredericton. We believe it is worth celebrating his celebrity."

Friedman, who was born and raised in New Jersey and began his career in California, says he's thrilled by the honour.

"I get friends in California saying to me, 'Stan, don't you miss being in California? What are you doing back there?' And I say, 'Yeah, I do miss the earthquakes and the horrible smog and the terrible traffic and the drive-by shootings and the drugs all over the place, but I've learned to do without those things.'"

Although Friedman has been a UFOlogist for more

than 40 years, he has yet to see an alien spacecraft.

He says his belief is founded in the data he has uncovered over the years about flying saucers and various UFO events, most of it buried in U.S. government documents.

"I have never seen a flying saucer and I have never seen an alien. But remember, I chased neutrons and gamma rays for a lot of years as a physicist and never saw one of them either," he says.

"In fact, I've never seen Tokyo, but I'm convinced it's there."

Friedman, who refers to himself as "a wandering Jew," says he has so far lectured at more than 600 colleges, addressed more than 100 professional groups and toured all 50 American states, as well as nine Canadian provinces, the Yukon and 16 other countries.

He has no plans for retirement, but he admits he has been at it for a long time.

"One reason I'm beginning to feel old, I did Merv Griffin twice and he just died," he says ruefully.

"I have never seen a flying saucer and I have never seen an alien. I've never seen Tokyo, but I'm convinced it's there."

Secret Of Space Visitors Exists  
In Spiritual Realm?**

What is the true story behind unidentified flying objects seen in the night sky over every corner of the planet for generations?

Are they, as leading UFO expert Stanton Friedman insists, strange visitors from another planet, or planets, so advanced in technology they are equipped to zoom in and out of Earth's atmosphere at will?

Does the secret actually lie within the spiritual realm, as some fundamentalist Christians maintain?

Many a Web site advocates the position that UFOs are nothing more than demon spirits, part of Satan's army, released in the "last days" to delude earthlings and provide a convenient explanation for the antichrist to explain the Rapture of the saints just before the seven-year Tribulation unfolds.

In a recent telecast, noted biblical author Jack Van Impe touted this idea, but his staff didn't respond to a request by The Register-Herald for a detailed account.

Nor was there any answer to a similar inquiry posted at the headquarters of Hal Lindsey, author of The Late Great Planet Earth, a best-seller on biblical prophecy in the early 1970s.

Friedman, a nuclear physicist, is a leading lecturer lined up for a two-day UFO summit this weekend in Charleston.

The Friday-Saturday event comes almost 55 years

to the day of the invasion by the so-called "Flatwoods Monster" in Braxton County, one that inspired two books by Frank Feschino, another key speaker at the Charleston gathering.

Feschino will be autographing his latest effort, Shoot Them Down, chronicling what he says was an aerial battle along the Atlantic Coast between aliens and Air Force jetfighters.

Friedman says one of the bigger objections to getting the truth spread about UFOs in modern times has come from the fundamentalist camp.

He quoted the late Rev. Jerry Falwell as dismissing so-called aliens as "the work of the devil," and insisting there is no intelligent life beyond Earth.

"What an insult to God if this is the best He could do," Friedman countered in a Register-Herald interview.

A new film titled Unidentified, produced by a Christian filmmaking outfit, explores the demonic theory in fiction.

As two magazine writers dig into a sighting in a small Texas town, a veteran government worker whose former agency was involved in the UFO controversy for years before his conversion, tells them, "I think the world is going to end soon and we're living in the last days. As Christians, we believe that the Rapture is the next big event on God's calendar. The devil knows this and he's going to do everything he can to explain the event away. Now, that's where the UFO phenomenon really comes into play."

A spokesman for John Hagee Ministries in San Antonio said he has heard the famed preacher's sermons for more than a decade but cannot remember any of them addressing UFOs.

"So I imagine that either he feels there is not much credence to the existence of UFOs, or that their existence is unverifiable, inconsequential in comparison to other, more pertinent issues, or a case of mistaken identify," Edward Martinez said.

There is no mention of UFOs in the Bible as modern man understands the term, he said.

## A Vintage UFO Case...

**Reverend William (Bill) Booth Gill...**  
**5 January 1928 - 13 June 2007...**  
**A man of service and integrity...**

A potent and compelling witness to the extraordinary 1959 UFO 'visitants' of Boianai Papua New Guinea.

I am saddened to report on the passing of Reverend William (Bill) Gill on 13 June 2007 at the age of 79. His funeral service was held at the Church of Holy Trinity, Anglican Parish of Surrey Hills, Melbourne, Victoria, Australia.

The first hint of the events to come, began on April 5, 1959, when Gill saw a light on the uninhabited Mount Pudi. This light, Gill stated, moved faster than anything he had ever seen. A month or so later, his assistant, Stephen Moi, saw an "inverted saucer-shaped object" in the sky above the mission. Gill dismissed these sightings as some sort of electrical or atmospheric phenomena. Little did he know, that these events, whatever they were, had drawn their attention to the sky above them, and soon William Gill would have one of the most celebrated UFO sightings to ever be documented, which was collaborated by a whole group of additional witnesses.

This extraordinary event would take place at 6:45 P.M., June 26, 1959. Father Gill saw what he described as a bright white light to the Northwest. Word of the sight spread quickly, and within a few moments, Gill was joined by no less than thirty-eight additional witnesses, including Steven Moi, Ananias Rarata, and Mrs Nettle Moi. According to sworn statements, these thirty-plus individuals watched a four-legged, disc-shaped object approximately the size of 5 full moons lined up end to end. This unbelievable craft was hovering over the mission! To their utter surprise, they saw four human-like figures that seemed to be performing a kind of task.

Now and then one of the figures would disappear, only to reappear in a moment or two. A blue light would shine up from the craft at what seemed to be regular intervals. The witness watched the craft and its activities for a full forty-five minutes, until the shining ship rose into the sky, and disappeared at 7:30 P.M. Glued to the sky, the witnesses would see several smaller objects appear at 8:30, and twenty minutes later, the first craft reappeared. This phenomenal occurrence would last an incredible four hours, until cloud cover obscured the view at 10:50. Father Gill prepared a full written report of this event, and 25 other observers signed the document.

This first sighting, a once in a lifetime occurrence, would incredibly be followed by another sighting the very next night. At 6:00 P.M., the larger object appeared again, with its occupants. It was shadowed by two of the smaller objects. In William Gill's own words; "On the large one, two of the figures seemed to be doing something near the center of the deck. They

were occasionally bending over and raising their arms as though adjusting or "setting up" something. One figure seemed to be standing, looking down at us."

(In a moment of anticipation, Gill raised his arms and waved to the figure.)

"To our surprise the figure did the same. Ananias waved both arms over his head; then the two outside figures did the same. Ananias and myself began waving our arms, and all four seemed to wave back. There seemed no doubt that our movements were answered...."

Gill and Ananias continued to occasionally wave, and their waves were returned. Another witness, Eric Kodawara, waved a torch, and there were acknowledgments from the craft. Gill went inside to eat, but when he came back, the craft was still there, only farther away (smaller). After a Church service, at 7:45, Gill again came outside to look for the craft, but clouds had appeared, and there was no sight of the object. The very next evening, the shining craft would make one more appearance. Gill counted eight of them at 6:45. At 11:20, Gill heard a loud bang on the roof of the mission. Going outside to see what had happened, he spied four UFOs in a circle around the building. These four craft were extremely high in the sky. The roof was checked for damage the next morning, but none was found.

IF you missed it then you didn't miss anything and if you watched it, then well, you probably have your own views.

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**The Isle of Wight**

**There's something on the wing some "Thing"**

You know when something sounds unbelievable but you know the person well and know they're telling the truth well this ones a little strange to say the least but the man involved is very reliable. The whiteness in this case is a most credible ex RAF pilot Mr W Davis of Cowes Isle of Wight who had a real close encounter whilst flying solo on a training mission over Gimmlie in Canada September 10th 1943. In fact it is so strange that all I can do is just let you hear his story and make up your own minds. There was a lot of written evidence to back up this case shame it wasn't reported earlier.

Mr Davis takes up the story:

It was night flight self navigation 2c two and three quarter hours, this was my last night flight before passing it was a fair old flight at approx. 130 mph. Right I'm going to stress now that I wasn't under any pressure because it was a night flight and nothing was bothering me at the time what so ever. We were easily failed if we were found to have stress problems etc. and on this flight even though I was alone this I was not unusual and i felt confident. The training just takes over you see and you feel relaxed. So nothing to stress me out or anything like that. Also I was a good navigator and was going to qualify as one after the training as well as a pilot, so I felt accomplished absolutely nothing to worry about I knew I had passed this was just the last flight not really necessary but you had to do it.

Now, I was based at Gimmlie on the shores of lake Winnipeg and this particular flight took me to Brandon and back again, somewhere between Brandon and



lake Minotober on the last leg home was where the incident happened. I had checked my track and there it was I was spot on so all I had to do was relax sit back and wait for the light of the control tower to pop up over the horizon. It was a beautiful night, clear moon and the visibility was great, there was a little snow on the ground which helps in navigation because you can see without the confusion of detail. So everything was perfect and all I had to do was wait. At times like this we were trained to scan the horizon all the time to make checks and observe, then you would pan across the control panels to make constant checks on the instruments. You were so used to seeing the instruments that if one was out your eyes would snap

right on to it all part of the training.

Well as I did one of these scans my eyes suddenly did snap onto something but not the instruments this was at the nose of the plane. Just on either side of the nose were two little lumps, well I scratched my head and thought I've never seen them before on an Anson, so I had a good look and if anything I thought they looked like engine ports, but the nose on an Anson is empty! Well as a pilot you have to know everything about your plane so I thought id better take notes as you do and investigate when I got back down on the ground. So I dismissed it and carried on with my scans of the horizon back and forth, suddenly my eyes caught some movement and they flashed back onto the nose again. These lumps were moving! I could clearly see they were hands! Then to my shock what I can only describe as an Elf or Pixie type creature climbed up and onto the nose of the plane. He, as it was male was about eighteen inches high and was wearing a leather pointed hat blue Grey in colour with stereotypical clothes like you would find on a picture of pixies from about a hundred years ago if that makes any sense to you. So there he was standing on the end, well the first thing I thought was "Christ" I'm going a hundred and thirty miles an hour and he or his clothes don't seem to be affected by the slipstream and I couldn't feel any effect on the wheel or anything.

So I thought well it must be a reflection or something but it became obvious to me that it wasn't because he was reflecting light himself from both the green port light and the red starboard light he was also reflecting the moonlight. Well there wasn't anything in the Book in dealing with this sort of thing so I thought I should just observe this thing that was standing just inches away from me on the other side of the cockpit glass. The Elf Pixie or Leprechaun type creature was about 18 inches high and was European in appearance with a well trimmed but full beard. Well at this point I thought I'd shut my eyes and open again and yes he's still there alright so I pinched myself and no I'm not dreaming either. He couldn't have been more than 12 inches away so I got up close to the windscreen. I was fascinated and he was so real that I could see the moonlight shining off his skin between the hairs in his high beard, that's how close I was. His skin colour was hard to tell because the moon was so bright that night so he looked kind of green gray but I'm not happy with that description because of the contamination of the moonlight and the wing lights reflecting of him. Then he seemed to be walking about a bit as if on some kind of inspection, then he suddenly stopped as if something caught his eye over my left shoulder but way out somewhere, he just stood there and was looking at it intently. I was naturally drawn to look in the same direction but I couldn't see anything unusual so I went back to studying him again, this time

I moved my head back and forth to make sure I couldn't see the stars through him and no I couldn't

so he was solid in that respect. This hole experience lasted just over a minute but it was a very long minute in my life, and then he seemed satisfied with what he had done you could see the look on his face, he did one last sort of sweep of the aircraft and just sat down on the nose! Now there's a propeller on each wing yet this little leprechaun or pixie just placed his hands either side of him and just jumped straight down off the nose and out of sight!

When I got back to base I didn't tell anyone at first because I would have been laughed at by some of the other pilots and probably considered insane or something, but after a few drinks I told a few I could trust. The thing is the next day in the barrack an older senior instructor came down to my barrack branch to see me, he said "are you the airman that saw that little man last?"

I said yes sir. He said "well look your not going mad don't let it worry son your not seeing things and your not alone either, several of us have seen them"

I couldn't question him because he's a senior officer but i presumed he meant here in Canada.

Well like I said before some things really do seem unbelievable, but I can tell you that Mr Davis has all the credentials no history of mental illness and his detail in his story is incredible and never changes, he has all the qualification's and has kept it quiet for so long because it just seemed too strange to tell anyone except close relatives. He has an open mind and has always been interested in the cutting edge of science and believes that his experience will one day be explained.

In conclusion I suppose its worth mentioning that Mr Davis knows that *what* he saw was there and that light was reflected off the pixie or leprechaun as i like to call him, but that the elements seemed to have no effect it. You see small Irish men climbing on the nose of moving aircraft without the proper safety equipment not only posses a serious heath and safety hazard but the aerodynamics of the plane would be altered, but at no point did Mr Davis feel anything unusual with the planes handling. Also the creature seemed to perform a task then once completed disappeared, well pilots the world over as you will know have been buzzed occasionally by all manner of strange craft that seem to perform an useless task then vanish mysteriously. Maybe Mr Davis's little man was the same phenomena as the glowing lights mini discs and cigar shaped craft that seem to observe the aircraft of later dates. Perhaps for instance, and this is a big jump, that some things are observing our crafts from time too time but to keep their identity secret they use the form somehow of whatever social beliefs of the time exist. For example the pixies and elves of the past could be the bog-eyed Grey skinned little men of today.

Or this hole thing could be some kind of super advance psychological experiment, but really I'm stumped on this one your guess is as good as mine but I do believe that Mr Davis is telling the truth about what he saw but what we see can sometimes be all that one wants us to see.

F.S.R. – Earth faults interesting UFO's? America let off Atom bomb deep in Earth's crust in 1963.

Aug 19/68

Heard on BBC Radio, morning news. Inhabitants of Arrenal, village in North West Spain, invaded by millions of beetle like insects, an inch high with long antennae, 96 legs. They entered homes and fields and consumed everything that was edible including flowers. Visiting scientists and biologists were baffled – species unknown to them. Sept 11/68

News on radio. Police investigating strange force that is stopping cars on the old Roman road at Egerton, Devon. One man claims to have felt dizzy and sick. Gil says the report he heard, stated the place to be "Dorset".

Sept 13/68

Florence declares she saw a UFO the previous evening just before 6 o'clock (10 mins to 6) – a small brilliant round thing with a dark "shadow" on one side, circling around and then going straight making roughly in the direction of Southampton.

Sept 13/68

On the radio – news of invisible "monster" at Seaford, Sussex. Never seen, but noticed from 1958 – 1962 as complete lines and tackle disappear – even a 12' – 6" long rod "went under".

Sept 15-16/68

Chaotic floods all over South and S.W. Kent – Surrey etc.

Sept 18/68

News of Russian satellite passing to within 1,000 miles of the moon.

Swarm of "Flying Daddy Longlegs" at Hove. (Due to weather?).

Sept 22 week/68

Severe earthquakes under the Pacific Ocean.

Oct 68

Oct issue of Fate – many strange animals seen in America – "Large cats", Pumas etc vanish when given chase.

Oct 8/68

News on Radio – Great gaping holes appearing in parts of Spain. Madrid – tree and cars and buildings disappeared into deep hole as the road collapsed. (subsidence or Earth faults collapsing?) UFO's under ground?

Oct 14/68

News of earthquake near Perth, Australia – 34 injured.

Nov 11<sup>th</sup>

Russian spaceship round moon. Jodrell Bank receiving signals and heard voices counting. They think no humans are aboard, but voices may be recorded.

Nov 15<sup>th</sup>

News about spaceship quiet for 24hrs. News of Russian space probe round moon in September – there were turtles and wireworms on board – all in good health on return – except for slight trouble with liver.

November – Russians set up and put into orbit a space station.

Nov 21/68


Heard on morning news – thousands of people in British Isles saw flying lights in the sky with fiery tails like rockets, flying North to South direction. Over Sussex it was described as a ball of fire with a fiery tail. Reporter from BBC coming home from Eastbourne saw six brilliant lights through his windscreen – got out of his car and found many other people had done the same and were watching these lights flying in perfect formation. Jodrell Bank also tracked them on their new giant telescope and said that probably they were the remains of the rocket breaking up that launched the recent Russian satellite!

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## UFO's & a Ghostly tale...

Ernie Sears relates a ghostly tale from a recent radio interview concerning his grandfather's name... a strange experience indeed.



Saturday 7th July 07 and I was sat at my radio awaiting a programme hosted by Xan Phillips (Shaun) on Southampton's 'Original' 106fm on which I was speaking along with ex-MOD's Nick Pope and Ray Bowyer, the airline pilot who has gone worldwide with his sighting of an immense 'craft' which hovered near one of the Channel Islands for about nine minutes, at about 2,000 ft before it vanished, in April this year.

NOW comes the 'crunch' item... and be warned. Throughout the 2 hour programme presenter XAN kept calling me, 'Ernie Saunders'. Not until the very end did he substitute 'Sears' for 'Saunders'.

No apology was given me at any time, Not even, SO FAR, in reply to my letter to XAN! Comments from listeners... notably Steve Gerrard, Founder, and Leader of the SUFOG organisation and Mike Rutter of our own WSG who's comments were 'scathing' 'I wasn't bothered'! Since 'SAUNDERS' was my late grandfather's surname and ever since my abduction in January '78, I'd 'acquired certain 'powers' that later on and reading Whitley Streiber's, books, 'Transformation' and 'Communion Letters' that UFO percipients and more so abductees, found they could 'heal', conduct ESP, contact those who'd passed on and other such things formerly classed as 'spiritual' and coming under paranormal. Thus it was that attending 'spiritual' churches and such I would often be approached by visiting clairvoyants who would describe a military gentleman in full uniform with busby and kilt etc... And possessing a very strong personality who I realised was 'Bert' Saunders, my long deceased grandfather, who had been a regimental sergeant major in a Scottish regiment in World War One. He had been a great influence in my young child days and I had often been assured he was stood next to me with his arm around my shoulders. This had happened when I was investigating spiritualism not long after my first UFO encounter in 1960. (I had reasoned that 'my' UFO had vanished into the clear blue sky as two meteor jets

approached it. 'Spooks' were reputed to vanish in the same manner...!) I was visiting, unknown to anyone there, a small 'church' in Gosport (where my UFO encounter took place) and indeed, I lost all doubts about 'life after death' that day and from subsequent events. So... 'Saunders'... of course that would have been my grandmother's surname and my own mother's maiden name too.

Plus I am 'BERT'... just like my grandfather, although I don't use that much nowadays except in legal matters or where 'security' demands it.

I have even reasoned that the whole set-up of that broadcast was 'organised' by my grandfather. SUFOG's group leader, founder, editor Steve Gerrard would no doubt confirm the fact that I did the talk in place of him (and I do... Editor) and that the 'five minutes' original broadcast was, in fact much, much longer when it happened.

One last point. As I relaxed after the broadcast... it was a two hour slot, I thought how great it was that I'd been able to say what I wanted in full.

The smell of tobacco crept into my nostrils. I sniffed. My grandfather smoked a pipe!

PS! YES... no longer amazing are the corroborative items that add even more persuasion to facets of the UFOlogical conundrum that I call under the heading 'paranormal'. Again, following the Scottish aspect of our broadcast, actually, on the 26th July, a phone call from a gentleman who urgently required additional photos from Portsmouth Harbour for an article that was due to appear in THE SCOTSMAN (!) on Sunday the 29th concerning UFO's! YEAH!!! Seems he was the "unknown" person who got George's photos from the MOD in June 2006, Hah! I was unable to fulfil his request to send the photos by email since my Amstrad emailer doesn't do attachments. I passed Steve Gerrard's phone number to him and our leader and founder was unable to get a selection off in the two hours left for the Sunday deadline. Currently I am expecting a copy of the Sunday magazine issue after posting my cheque for £90 to a 'back issue' agency. Meanwhile Steve had downloaded THE SCOTSMAN's internet

site on Sunday but was indignant that the article did not even mention SUFOG or Steve or yours truly and added insult to injury by apparently removing & obscuring my copyright logo from some of the seven photos published!

Steve had got a complaining email off to the article author that contained the word 'legal!' Naturally, since the MOD wrote me last year telling me they'd fulfilled the request from the Freedom of Information files to this 'unknown' guy for any UFO photos... they sent him mine I'd sent to the MOD previously... their letter says they warned the chap that the photos were under copyright. However... I'm awaiting the actual magazine issue to check the photos which are not very clear on the internet download. I have NO DOUBT my 'dead' grandfather is keeping a spectral eye on his 'plans' progress! My family solicitor has also been alerted. Interesting that copies of those same photos had been sent to Dr. David Clarke at Hallam University (currently handling Capt. Ray Bowyer's Channel Islands Sighting!) and had come back in a crabby envelope with 'Not known at this address'... proved to be a lie from the email we sent to the University hierarchy and subsequent phone call!

The plot thickens!

There are no 'coincidences' in the world of the paranormal... only synchronicities... as Carl Gustav Jung would have it. Thus : a short while after the foregoing incidents, I laughingly said 'Oh no' as I watched a TV James Bond film, as a Scottish bagpipes player played from the ruins of a Scottish castle. Followed by... on a visit to a weekend of demonstrations of peoples hobbies and interests at our local Country Park when I was faced with a trio of kilted Scottish bagpipe players as we drove into the car park. Subsequently meeting more such as we reached the area where they were due to play!

I was able to give them a quick resume (much to their astonishment!) of my recent encounters with my deceased grandparent!

I don't care, see! THE TRUTH must be told. Today... the 20th of August... I had some copies of the Scotland on Sunday UFO article printed, in order to circulate such, near and far. Articles planned to include my weekly PSYCHIC NEWS... fingers crossed!

In the interim, my sister was contacted and sent me her treasured photo of my grandfather 'Bert' Saunders which I will add to planned articles.

My second sighting occurred on August 12th 2007 at 23:30 pm. I had gone out into my garden (same location as previous incident), to watch the Perseid meteor shower. I saw a couple of meteors, but was soon distracted by a bright light in the sky, close to the tree line, in approximately the same place where the UFO had first got my attention in the previous encounter. I noticed that the bright light kept falling in the sky, like a spider dropping on a thread. It would then rise slowly, hover for a while, before dropping again. I watched it repeat this many times for about 20 minutes before knocking on my neighbor's door to show her it. She had seen a bright light the night of the first incident and asked me to let her know if I saw anything again.

The sky conditions were very clear on both nights in question.

Phoned police who were not interested and gave a phone number in Biscester, Oxford (I assume Contact International who gave the witness our phone number).



## THE PARANORMAL HAS ARRIVED IN SUFOG...



### En Linea Directa... 15th July 2007... Chupacabras Strikes Again in Reynosa, Tamaulipas, Mexico...

According to an article published by journalist Armando Garcia in the En Linea Directa newspaper, rural growers of Reynosa fear for the lives of their animals... and their own lives as well, since a strange animal has appeared out of nowhere to mutilate cattle.

A rancher from the El Porvenir collective farm reported the deaths of several animals on the property, since after a two day absence from the farm, the owner returned to find that part of his herd was also dead, while other animals were still dying. Alarmed, he informed the authorities in hopes of starting an investigation.

Ricardo Humberto Varela, 50, lives at Rio Alamo 61, Colonia Longoria, and filed his complaint before Gerardo Trevino, a public magistrate, who in turn reported what had taken place at the Artecitas ranch in the El Porvenir collective farm.

The statement said that the rancher was startled to see what was happening in his ranch, since after a two-day absence, he found part of his herd dead. He checked each animal physically and found two puncture marks on their necks through which something had exsanguinated them.

He then inspected each corner of the ranch to determine what had taken place. He found the print marks of two small feet or claws, seemingly those of a strange entity or animal that broke into the ranch several times, slaying the livestock. The rancher lost 14 sheep, 10 chickens and five goats. While this official report makes no mention of the Chupacabras, it is believed that the modern mythical entity is responsible for this attack.

Ricardo Humberto Varela noted that he would destroy the carcasses by fire, but before doing so, he took several photographs that were appended to the investigation, which was given the number 295/007, as evidence of what had transpired at the "Artecitas" ranch in the El Porvenir collective.

It will be up to the police to ascertain the nature of the mysterious assailant on the ranch. It should be noted that in previous years, similar cases had been reported. If a new "Chupacabras" wave is involved - a creature believed by some to be an invention or pure fiction, the collective ranchers of Reynosa will fear for the lives of their animals and their own, as no one has been able to guess the creature's true nature.

### Russia-InfoCenter - Moscow, Russia... 20th July 2007...

UFO And Anomalous Zones Map Published In Russia. A detailed map of all anomalous and mystical zones of the Moscow Region has appeared in Moscow shops. One of the maps creators, specialist of the Centre of Regional and Geophysical Researches Mikhail Lodzhevskiy says that the map is based on stories told by the anomalies' witnesses, but it also contains some scientific information: land faults, gas volcanoes, and geological anomalies.

"We are sure that all things in nature are dependent on one another. This is why we decided to check whether the anomalous phenomena were linked with faults and geological anomalies. Undoubtedly, the information about UFO can be disputed. We do not claim that a place marked with an UFO sign on the map is a real place of UFO

landing, but we mean that here there has been noticed something that was interpreted as UFO. The same concerns the other anomalies on the map - it is meant that in these places something unusual and unexplained has been registered", as Mikhail Lodzhevskiy comments.

### Crop Circle Formations in the UK... 15th June - September...

**Location:** Boreham Down, Lockeridge. West Woods  
**Map:** SU137664 **Crop:** Wheat **Description:** Looks like large circle with standing parts **Discovery:** 16/06/07

**Location:** Near the crossroads, at Alton Barnes **Map:** **Crop:** Wheat **Description:** A polo mint circle from what I could see from the road, **Discovery:** 6.00 am 19th Tuesday June 07 Thanks to my vigilant pilot who noticed this Flower formation on Clatford Down a few days ago, we flew yesterday evening (June 22) and got some shots of it before it got too old -- he was dodging rain clouds along the way! It's located inside an oval gallops (that's a first!) between Manton House and Redpost Farm, at approximately SU 155-705 on the Ordnance map.

**Location:** Westwoods near Lockeridge **Map:** **Crop:** Wheat **Description:** Circle, maybe two half circles on the edges **Discovery:** 6.00 am, Sunday 24th June 07

**West Kennett Long Barrow, Nr Avebury, Wiltshire. Reported 28th June.** The doors of deception. Corridor with doors leading off to the left and right into the distance.

**Golden Ball Hill, Nr Alton Barnes, Wiltshire. Reported 29th June.** Now one year later on June 29, 2007, those mysterious crop artists have continued the same theme, by drawing an even more theoretically advanced picture of a ring hole at Golden Ball Hill. It shows the expected "two angular horizons", and also a "shielded craft" entering from one side.

**Southend, Nr Garsington, Oxfordshire. Reported 29th June.** Large 200 feet long formation, consists of two sets of 3 nested crescents either side of 30 feet diameter circle. Two 12 ft circles at top and bottom. Looks well formed and totally symmetrical. Aerial photo a must. Located in hotspot field which has had 4 formations in 5 years.

**Stantonbury Hill, Nr Marksbury, North Somerset. Reported 7th July.** The short bar with circles either side is a way of signifying yin. The two longer bars with no dots represent yang. So we have one yin with two yang above. This is the trigram WIND. Wind means gentle effects, small efforts, penetrating work. Wind is akin to wood and relates to early summer, mild movement and the body part of thigh.

**Location:** Garsington, Oxfordshire - in the field opposite to the other one going towards Toot Baldon  
**Map:** SP576008 **Crop:** Wheat **Description:** Hexagon and cube **Discovery:** 7th July

**Location:** Below Garsington, viewed from the church past other crop circle. **Map:** SP573008 **Crop:** Wheat **Description:** Heaxagon sun design, very complicated difficult to make out need ariel shot! **Discovery:** 9th July

**Hat Gate Cottage, Nr Savernake Forest, Wiltshire. Reported 11th July.**

**Stanton Bridge, nr Honey Street, Wiltshire. Reported 14th July.** Stanton Bridge of July 14 seems to show the nine planets of our Solar System, each in some specific angular location about the Sun, where different orbital distances have been omitted for clarity. Thus we see Jupiter (largest), Saturn (next largest), Uranus, Neptune and so on, in order of decreasing size. The calendar date so specified could be unique within the past 5000 or next 5000 years.

**Hailey Wood, Nr Ashbury, Oxfordshire. Reported 16th July.** The Butterfly formation.

**Hinton Downs, Bishopstone, Oxfordshire. Reported 16th July.** A Fractal Tree growing from an ancient Tumulus

**Cannings Cross, Nr All Cannings, Wiltshire. Reported 17th July.** The formation is 722 feet from the grapeshot at the bottom to the tiny circle at the top. The largest circle and ring is 146 ft. in diameter. In comparison, the pictogram that appeared at the West Overton T-junction in 2003 was 656 feet from the smallest feature at the top to the smallest at the bottom. And its largest circle and ring were 118 feet in diameter.

**Wilton Water Grid, nr Wilton, Wiltshire. Reported 18th July.** The formation is approximately 300' across with a central large circle, eight orbiting additional circles, surrounded by a ribbon of partial circular arcs all contained within a 300' ring. This is also the first formation in OATS that we've come across. The oats were about 4' tall.

**White's Hill, nr Ramsbury, Wiltshire. Reported 18th July.** I notice that the following crop circle, White's Hill, nr Ramsbury, Wiltshire, reported 18th July White's Hill, seems to resemble the periodic table of elements. It's a connection of rectangles, but if you look at the crop diagram, imagine seeing it from a viewpoint down within the ground. There you see a similarity to the basic structure of the periodic table, yet the diagram has new islands of elemental structure, perhaps representing new inter-relationships between elements and physics of a new sort.

**Clifford's Hill, nr All Cannings, Wiltshire. Reported 19th July.** It is six fold geometry built around six sets of three truncated vesica pisces in "propeller" form. Each of the 18 truncated vesica pisces have a 10" border of wheat tracing the outline of their form, both standing and laid portions. The outer limit of the formation is made of six fairly wide arc sections with half the wheat laid in one direction and half the other. They appear as if powerful waves of wheat flowed in opposite directions, crashing in the middle forcing some to stand up and others to swirl.

**Martinsell Hill, nr Oare, Wiltshire. Reported 19th July.** consists of 18 intersecting circles.

**Cherry Tree pub, Great Stambridge, Essex. 19th July 2007**

**Great Wakering, nr Southend, Essex.**

**Collingham, nr Bardsey, West Yorkshire. Reported 23rd July.** solid circle approx 15m in diameter surrounded by two further concentric circular shells. There are also two channels that run off at about 75° from one another, one straight, one slightly wavy. The straight(er) one is about 12m in length. The wavy one is longer, perhaps 20m. Each of the channels forks at the end, and these forked channels fork again after 2-3m, running only for a further 2-3m before stopping (almost reminiscent of the Uffington white horse).

**West Kennett, Nr Avebury, Wiltshire. Reported 25th July.** The "three faith" West Kennet formation (July 26) is also a symbol for Mercury, a basic element in Alchemy.

**Chute Causeway, Nr Mount Cowdown, Wiltshire. Reported 26th July.** A star burst explodes onto a remote part of the English landscape. This wonderful formation has appeared in a very difficult location to find. It cannot be seen from the ground as it is 8 tram lines into the middle of a large wheat field and hidden from the road by a small wood.

**Green Street, Nr Avebury, Wiltshire. Reported 29th July.** Appearing in a field close to the Avebury Circle this delightful three-fold has similarities to a triskelion or triskele that's "three legged" or "tri-armed". This form of three-fold rotational symmetry was often employed by Celtic illuminators in border patterns and a superb example of a triskele was laid down by "The Circlemakers" at Trottiscliffe (Trosley) in Kent, way back in '99.

**Etchilhampton Hill, nr Devizes, Wiltshire. Reported 31st July. Crop: Wheat Description: Looks like Meaden's plasma vortex??? Circle with a ring of crop 100??? ft. Discovery: July 31, 2007 Found in morning after camping on the hill**

**Milbourne, nr Malmesbury, Wiltshire. Reported 25th July. Map: ST948882 Crop: Wheat Description:**

Single circle with a large ring around **Discovery: 25th July 2007**

**Sugar Hill, nr Upper Upham, Wiltshire. Reported 1st August.** The 18 cube circle appeared on Aug 1, or 8/1

**Draycot Foliat, nr Chiseldon, Wiltshire. Reported 1st August.** Only about 50 feet in diameter. The formation consisted of a large ring within which lay a central circle, swirled counter-clockwise, five straight "bars" of laid-down crop bisecting it (or 7 bars if you count the two parts of the tram line that paralleled the five laid-down lines of crop) plus a smaller circle, also swirled counter-clockwise, along the formation's edge furthest from the Ridgeway that actually was mostly outside the formation's outer ring.

**Pewsey White Horse, nr Pewsey, Wiltshire. Reported 4th August. Location: Pewsey white horse Map: Crop: wheat Description: Large circle, boxes triangle points Discovery: 6.30 am Saturday 4th august 07**

**Westwoods (3), Nr Marlborough, Wiltshire. Reported 9th August.** 3 central circles with a further 6 circles around the outside edge.

**Stanton St Bernard, nr Alton Barnes, Wiltshire. Reported 12th August.** A new crop formation at Stanton St. Bernard showed a long bar beneath a filled dot, that clearly was meant to represent the Mayan number six. Its message was apparently "six days after this current new Moon on August 12, we may see a significant event on August 18".

**West Overton, nr East Kennett, Wiltshire. Reported 17th August.**

**North Down, nr Beckhampton, Wiltshire. Reported 19th August. Location: North Down, Wiltshire Map: 68.05 Crop: wheat Description: Large formation containing for sides with four mini outer circles Discovery: 19/08/07**

**The Ridgeway, nr Hackpen Hill, Wiltshire. Reported 30th August.** One large central circle with 3 small circles crossing the central one and a further 'dumbell' formation crossing the larger circle.

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### **Argentina: New Cattle Mutilations In La Pampa...**

On July 30, 2007, two beef cattle were found slain and mutilated at the San Jorge ranch located on Provincial Route No. 28, between rural routes 11 and 13 and between the locality of Cuchillo Co (some 250 km south of Santa Rosa) and the Sierras de Lihue Calel.

The mutilated cows were black Aberdeen Angus'

with missing ears, tongues, incisions to their jawbones and missing udders. One of them was lying on its side and another on its back; the carcasses presented signs of extreme hardness in the limbs and hide. Upon being struck with a stick "...they sounded hollow, like a drum..."

Witnesses to the find were Marcelino Martinez and Hector Ruiz, a rural contractor and his employee, who were refurbishing and building rural homes.

It should be noted that there is no rural electricity in this region, and generators are employed for power. This circumstance keeps the locals from having access to television or radio (battery units excluded) and the only residents in the area are either transient or temporary.

At midnight on the night prior to the find, Ruiz decided to go out of the place he shares with Martinez to walk and smoke. It was here, and unexpectedly, that he saw a bright source of light at low altitude. It remained static "and gave out lights on all sides - red, green, blue, yellow..."

The light, whose width was equivalent to the length of a cattle cage used for transporting livestock (some 10/12 meters), according to Ruiz's comparison, vanished after a few seconds and another smaller light appeared on the ground, but this time an intense bright green. Within this light was "...as small being standing some 50/70 centimetres tall, who remained motionless...". At this point Ruiz specifies "...I cannot say if it had a head and ears, but it was humanlike, since two legs could be seen..." This sighting lasted only a few seconds before the entity vanished altogether. The witness was deeply impressed by what he had seen, and decided to go back to bed and sleep.

Subsequently, and as is customary during work breaks, Ruiz and Martinez decided to explore the vicinity. Martinez found one of the cows in the proximity of a cutwater; the other cow was also found near another cutwater, both located within the rural premises. At this point they decided to inspect the place where Ruiz had seen the lights, some 40 meters from the place they spent the night. On the ground they located four holes measuring 2 cm in diameter and some 20 cm distant from each other, forming a square.

This ranch (San Jorge) was also the scene for several cases involving cow, horse, sheep and goat mutilations between 2002 and 2004. Both Martinez and Ruiz live in General Acha, some 120 km south of Santa Rosa, stating that in the area where the animals were found, it is quite common to see lights of various types and colours.

**How spooky is Hampshire?**

That's what a group of paranormal investigators is hoping to find out.

The UK Paranormal Research Society (UKPRS), which is based in Hampshire, is launching a new

project to find out more about the haunted locations of the county.

They are asking members of the public to contact them if they own a house, pub or other property which they think might be haunted and are willing to have a team spend the night running experiments in it.

The investigations are run on a voluntary basis but may give the property owners an interesting insight into who or what is sharing their space.

Whether owners have witnessed poltergeist activity, heard footsteps when there was no one there, felt cold spots, seen orbs, heard voices or just had the strong feeling that there was another worldly presence in their property the group wants to hear from them.

UKPRS has carried out overnight paranormal investigations in suspected haunted buildings across the country.

The researchers use séances to attempt to contact spirits who may be dwelling in a property as well as crystals, automatic writing, psychic art and mediums.

They also attempt to take a more scientific approach to their work, using EMF readers, Dictaphones, night vision cameras and more.
