
Press/Tv/Radio matters over the past month 15.4.93 - 15.5.93...

Television :

28th April 1993 : Daily Mail :

When I saw the title of the article, I was left wondering...
'Enter Sea Stealth'...



The picture that follows appeared in the paper. It appears that it was designed using the same technology that was used in the Stealth aircraft. It is about the size of a Sea Cat cross-channel hydrofoil and is the ultimate killer of the deep. Officially it is a test craft called Sea Shadow, the world's first invisible ship. It is covered with black radar-absorbing paint & has no hard angles or sloping sides that radar signals can latch on to. It is controlled by a handful of experts using technology still in its infancy.

Facts and figures :

Weight : 560 tons.
Speed : 13 knots.
Length : 160ft.
Width : 70ft.

It has cost around £158million to develop and has taken 11 years in the making. It appears that the Swedes have developed a version even more futuristic and more ugly. It has a weapons system that pops up and fires and then disappears back into the hull.

(If we are to believe that the Stealth technology came from either flying saucers that have been captured by the US or from the Aliens that are supposed to exist in some top secret underground base in Nevada, then one of the questions that comes to my mind is, have the Swedes captured their own flying saucer and aliens? and, if this technology has come from outer space, then what else has the United States government or any other country, got hidden away in some top secret base?...ED.)

Magazine Review :

As ever, one of, if not the best magazines on crop circles you can buy. Paul produces a very readable magazine, which keeps you up to date in the field of crop circles. A look at the crop circle rings in Canada in the 1970's, A very interesting interview with Doug Bower by Clas Svahn, and many more informative articles. 2. Fortean Times : No 68 (£2 per copy). Another magazine worth a look at if you are interested in strange phenomenon. In this edition, there is a look at a photo taken of a ufo that appeared in the Westmorland Gazette. But was it really a cloud? Also, an article that looks at cattle mutilations in America and possible alien connections, an interview with Mary Seal, conspiracy researcher (organiser of a conference at Wembley in January That Exposes A Global Deception. The only thing appears to of been exposed was that it was a total fiasco). Also, there is a look at the 1992 crop circles by John Michell. And finally, Dennis Stacy charts new developments in the standard Abduction Scenario.

3. OVNI. Produced by the Phenomenon Research Association in Derbyshire. Group Leader Omar Fowler.

4. SKYLINK (London Ufo Studies Group). No 4. £4/4 Issues.

If you want a magazine packed with ufo sightings and info, then this is the magazine for you. I have read my copy over and over again and is great value. 5. UFO MAGAZINE (QUEST INTERNATIONAL) : Vol 11 No 6.

As ever, the magazine is packed with news, views and material that may prove controversial in time to come. If you want a hard hitting magazine, then consider this for your library. I must admit, I sometimes find some of their views etc a little bit hard to swallow, but this is only my view. For production and quality in presentation, then I think you would find it difficult to find a British publication on ufos to equal it. 6. FORSIGHT. At around £2 for 4. I found this an interesting little magazine. When I opened it, I did not know what to expect, but I was pleasantly surprised. It has a couple of interesting articles and a number of press reports re-produced on such subjects as the photo showing Hitler's body, the meteor that nearly hit earth!, a press cutting concerning ufos seen over the Shetland Isles and an article looking at 'ancient ufos', possibly built by the Nazi's?. New Book Review...

I have just obtained a copy of Timothy Goods new book : Alien Update. It is as good as ever and I highly recommend the avid Ufologist to add it to their collection. Packed with ufo reports/sightings and some intriguing chapters. It is an account of the latest developments in the ufo scene, bringing the expertise of an international team to bear on this extraordinary worldwide phenomenon. I have picked out the following chapters :

Ufos over Washington DC, April 1992 : George Wingfield.

Close encounters in Romania : Gheorghita Florin.

Important Developments in the Former Soviet Union : Nikolai Lebedev.

1992 Animal Mutilations Update : Linda Moulton Howe.

These are but a few of the chapters that appear in the book and it kept me intrigued for hours. At around £4.99 for a paperback, I couldn't put it down.

Recent Ufo activity in Ireland.....

As I mentioned in a previous newsletter, I have finally been able to track down a press cutting from Ireland relating to the sightings. I must thank Mr John Price for supplying me with it. I have been unable to reproduce the full article (a copy is available from the Editorial address), so here are a few points from the article :

Bizarre Night Of Ufos ! Dublin Evening Press : 31.3.93...

Two eye witness accounts reported to the Gardai, were to be investigated by the Department of Transport.

A large mysterious object with lights and emitting a vapour was reported to air traffic control at Shannon from far away as Cork and Donegal.

The first report came from two Gardai in Co Limerick at 1.13 am.

Most reports came in between 2.00am and 2.15 am and the number of objects varied from 2 - 4.

The two Gardai officers saw a large object with two bright lights, one at the front and the other at the back.

It made no noise at all, and it left a sort of vapour trail like a jet behind it.

The department of transport said that their Air Navigation Services Section were looking into the matter.
