Round-up of recent sightings/reports :

Ufo sightings over the past two weeks have been flooding in. One
of the first reports came from the Bristol area around the end
of June. It appears up to 30 people have seen up to 8 objects
over the area between 23.00hrs - 06.00hrs in the morning.
(more on these sightings in next months newsletter, as I hope
to be getting press cuttings from the area).

Warminster seems to be waking up to the ufo phenomena again...
At the end of June, two objects were reported flying towards
Cley hill. Then following this, a circle was found in grass on
Cop Heath nr Cradle hill. The circle was about 15ft across and
was burnt in places. Also, there was a report of 5 shooting stars
seen over the Warminster area together (Is this a natural thing
or not (ED)).

(a friend went up to Cop Heath following the report, only to
find that the whole area had been mowed very short and there
was no sign of the circle... (I wonder why and who by... ED).

Then, over Southampton at the end of June, up to eight objects were seen over towards Totton. The witness, first sighted a group of eight orange/yellow circles of light, in no real formation, in the sky. These then appeared to disappear. Then, to the left, the objects returned, but in groups of two on top of each other, with one light at a great height. These also appeared to go out and disappear. Then, in the same area as the first sighting, two objects that looked like they were 'driving' down a mountain road, the lights sweeping around the tight corners, and these disappeared never to be seen again.

Then, the icing on the cake, was the possible filming of two ufos over Warminster, about the 3rd of July. (More news on this in the next issue).

(What is the connection if any, between the above sightings..ED)

New Light on Ghoulies :

Mysterious lights in remote marshes, glowing shapes floating through dank Gothic cemeteries - the very stuff of ghost stories. It was long thought that the palely loitering Will O' the Wisp was connected with methane, or marsh gas, but how could it ignite spontaneously ?

Now, reports New Scientist, Gunter Gassman and Dieter Glindemann of the Helgoland Biological Institute in Hamburg say the culprit is diphosphane, derived from phosphates and produced in the same strongly reducing chemical conditions as methane - as in decaying corpses in damp ground. They found it in the digestive tracts of cows and pigs. In humans concentrations are even higher because we eat more phosphates in processed meats and cheeses and cola drinks. Diphosphane burns spontaneously when released into the air, providing the needed ignition.

And so it seems that Will O' The Wisp, like Jumping Jack Flash, is a gas, gas, gas....
