Press/Tv/Radio matters over the past month 15.7.93 - 15.8.93..

Radio :

This past 4 weeks has seen a couple of items on the radio to quickly mention :

On the 15 July, Radio 3 at 8.25am...A report made by the pilot of a BOAC British Airways airliner on an internal domestic flight. At the time of the sighting, the aircraft was over Scotland. The pilot and co-pilot saw a large disc-like object and 3 smaller objects, that emerged from the larger object. These smaller objects then disappeared in different directions. The sighting appears to of been confirmed by another pilot and crew of a second aircraft on a domestic flight. They simultaneously saw the released objects.

(So who says only 'ordinary' people see ufos....ED).

To date, I have not come up with any press items etc in relation to this item, so if anyone can come up with anything, I would be very grateful. Sorry, but I donot even have the date of the sighting.....

On the 19.7.93 at 17.15hrs on the John Dunn show on Radio 2, was the following item....

A listener to the show had written in to relate his sighting of the infamous 'FOO' fighters of the second world war...The sighting took place in either 1944 - 45, when the witness was in an aircraft on a bombing raid over Germany. To throw off the flak guns on the ground, they released orange flares..On this particular mission, the crew of the aircraft sighted an orange ball tracking the bomber. It was too bright too look at and appeared to be controlled, in that it followed the bomber. It was not a reflection, as the bomber was on a straight and level course and it was behind the aircraft. It then moved away towards the orange flares, mingled with them, finally disappearing.

The writer wanted to know if anyone had solved the mystery of the FOO fighters as the Americans called them.

Television...

On the 23rd July...at 10pm on Cable Tv on Wire Tv was a feature about the recent ufo activity in Bristol.I was not able to record it,so it was probably on a local network programme.It run for an hour and appears to of contained some interesting material.(Information about this and the Bristol wave,is available from the new ufo group based in Bristol). Round-up of recent sightings/reports :

In the last edition of the newsletter,I mentioned the
sighting of a ufo over Southampton water.Following a telephone
conversation with Maria Ward,the following was brought to my
attention.It appears that on the same night as the sighting in
Southampton,it appears that 8 objects,in pairs on top of each
other,were seen on the same night in another part of Hampshire
at Petersfield.The question is :

- 1) Did the ufo in Southampton jump into hyper space,as
Petersfield is about 40 miles from Southampton, or
- 2) Was it so big and bright,that the witness was able to see
the same object at the same time,some 40 miles away ?

Also,Maria had another ufo sighting reported to her in the
Southampton area.(As yet,I have not come across any press
reports or any other information to back up the sighting)..
The object was described as elliptical in shape,with lights at
the front.. (Does anyone else have any info on this sighting ?)

In my previous newsletters, I have mentioned a new secret programme based on Stealth. A boat, designed on the basis of a sea cat, covered in the same material as the Stealth fighter. It appears that recently, there has been a lot of activity in the North Sea, involving the Americans. The American theory is one of ufos doing undersea mining and they have been tracked on radar. One of these boats was towing a platform of instruments to track down these so called mining ufos. At the time, ufos were tracked on radar in the area. But the platform was later found drifting in the sea, and the boat had disappeared with its three man crew.....

Cattle Mutilations.

Early July 1993.....Two calfs, 3 months and 6 months respectively, found on a farm at Modcombe on the Wiltshire / Dorset boarder. Both had been mutilated, right ears removed, along with genitals, tongues & rectums. According to the vet that examined the animals, there was no sign trauma. Also on the same night, sheep were also found on the Yorkshire moors with the same mutilations. ~

(Also, about the same time, there was ufo reports in Southampton, Bristol and Petersfield (Hampshire).

CROP CIRCLE NEWS.....

In June, I was told about a new crop circle formation that had been found in a field at a place called Gussage All Saints in Dorset. The moment I was told about it, I informed Maria Ward, who was able to furnish me with the following information....

Formation found on the 3/4 July... The circles were 20 feet in dia, and swirled clockwise. The night that the formation was found, there was a powercut. also, dogs barked during the night and there was reports of rooks flying around. (Which is an unusual thing to happen, as rooks donot fly at night).

Crop circles have been numerous this year with a lot of them appearing along side motorways and very prominent sights, so that they can be easily seen.. Obviously such formations should be treated with care, as the hoaxers are still out and about. I have heard this year, that a formation has appeared right under police motorway cameras. It appears that the motorway cameras keep a watch from bridges of anyone broken down on the hard shoulder of the motorway. During the night, the camera went off for about 10 minutes. The cameras can pick up movements and are sensitive to light. Yet, the camera didn't pick up any movement during the night the formation formed... Curiouser & curiouser.

Circle formations have been numerous around the Oxford area (University Hoaxers ?).. And a pictogram west of junction 13 on the M4 which was a hoax. Two more circles North East of Silbury Hill, and two circles in a field South of Silbury Hill.

Sharp Decline In Mysterious Crop Designs.....By Andrew Napier.

It could be the end of a an era. After five summers of increasing numbers of crop circles this summer has seen a steep decline.

Only 45 circles have been spotted so far this year, compared to 400 in the summer of 1992 and the year before. Hampshire, with the centre of activity around Winchester and Andover, has seen very few.

Leading investigator Pat Delgado admits the decline might indicate that most were made by hoaxers.

He reckons that in recent years there were about 80 genuine circles a year, this year there has only been a couple.

"I don't know what is the answer to it. I have a wide open mind. It is still a fundamental mystery", he said.

Interest is still massive with a dozen groups of researchers scouring the skies for signs that the circles are made by something other than man.

Pat Delgado's three books, two written with Colin Andrews - a former official with Test Valley Borough Council - have sold just under 500,000 copies worldwide and been translated into four languages.

Mr Andrews emigrated to the United States, where he works full-time investigating the paranormal.

(Has Mr Andrews changed his profession...ED).

Round In Circles..By Jim Schnabel, Hamish Hamilton, £16.99...

Should you ever need a literary assassin to sneak up behind people and despatch them with minimum fuss then Jim Schnabel is your man.

Round in Circles, sub-titled Physicists, poltergeists, pranksters and the secret history of the crop-watchers, is a gentle but no less effective hatchet job on the researchers in the crop circle 'industry'.

For those who have been on another planet for the last five years, the phenomenon grew from merely local interest in the early 1980s to national coverage by 1988 to worldwide coverage the following year.

The author did not have to try too hard in poking fun. There is comic potential in the researchers sitting for hours through the night in caravans with high-tech monitoring equipment waiting for something to happen, quarrelling with others about the cause and vying for media attention.

The main players were Pat Delgado, from Alresford, and Colin Andrews, the former chief electrical engineer of Test Valley Borough Council, who risked ridicule by claiming the circles were formed by UFOs. They spent thousands of pounds of their own money and they had the last laugh when they made hundreds of thousands of pounds when their books sold by the warehouse

load.

There was Terence Meaden, the serious scientist, whose plasma vortex theory, put simply, descending whirlwinds, was continuously undermined by the ever more fantastic formations.

And then there were Doug and Dave, the Southampton sexagenarians, who spoiled the fun in 1991 when they claimed to have made most of the circles themselves. (You must be joking...ED)

In the wings were the minor players; the Japanese scientists, the astrologers, the conspiracy theorists, the New Agers, the ufologists, the dowzers and mediums.

For some the circles seemed to have a quasi-religious importance, while for others it fulfilled a need for mystery.

Readers will find much of local interest in this very well-written book : most of the formations were in the Winchester-Andover area and in Wiltshire...

(Pick the bones out of this one readers...I must admit, there is a photo from a couple of years ago of Pat Delgado, with a sub heading of : LAST LAUGH : Ufologist (Since when...ED) Pat Delgado...Will pat be happy with being brandished a Ufologist or not...ED).

12. Warminster...Just received a report that a large circle has appeared out side of the town.

On the 9th of August, I visited the famous town of Warminster and went along to the exhibition run by Ken Rogers. There was a number of press articles around the room on the wall, along with pictures of some of the well known pictograms. At the back of the room, was a collection of books and magazines for sale. When I arrived, there was a video featuring Ken Rogers video made around early 1990 and which has been extended by around an hour. But at around £25, a bit out of my reach... I spent around an hour talking to people and met one or two very interesting people.
