PRESS :

Independent (The) : 17.11.94 :

BRAIN POWER MAY INSPIRE 'ALIEN KIDNAPS'.

The article looks at an article in the New Scientist magazine by Dr Susan Blackmore. Michael Persinger of the university of Sudbury in Ontario, is trying to re-create alien abductions in the laboratory in the attempt to explain a rise in reported 'extra-terrestrial kidnappings'. Also, his experiment is to be included on the Horizon program to be screened on 28th November, in which Dr Susan Blackmore looks for evidence to back up peoples claims that they have encountered aliens from other worlds.

Daily Telegraph : 17.11.94 :

UFO ABDUCTIONS ALL IN THE MIND.

As with the above article, this article looks at Dr Susan Blackmore's New Scientist magazine article, and the Horizon program to be screened on the 28th November.

Independent On Sunday : 20.11.94 :

ILLEGAL ALIENS.

Holding fast their reputation for neutrality and a dislike of the wrong kind of foreigner, the Swiss have turned down an application to build an embassy for 'elohim', small visitors from outer space. 'We cannot discuss possible diplomatic status for the 'elohim' until they have landed and have been recognised as a community' under international law, the Foreign Ministry says.

The Geneva-based Rael movement, which asked for the embassy with a landing platform for flying saucers, believes life on Earth was created by the elohim. The Swiss could lighten up a bit and, like the Hungarians, prepare landing strips.

News Of The World : 20.11.94 :

PROFESSOR WHO BELIEVES IN ALIENS.

The article interviews Dr John E.Mack who has interviewed 100 people who claim they have had alien encounters. The article includes the stories of 4 people who tell their own stories about their alien abductions.

CHECKING FOR SPACE INVADERS.

The article reviews the Horizon program presented by Dr Susan Blackmore on the alien abduction phenomenon. The article ends with 'Still, she reached the only possible conclusion - slim evidence at the moment but who (or Dr Who if you like) can tell' ?

The Observer : 4.12.94 :

DYING FOR AN AMERICAN DREAMLAND.

This is a fascinating article, that looks at Dreamland (Or Area 51 in Nevada), and looks at a young lawyer, Jonathan Turley, who will file a Motion to Compel the US government to name whatever lies beside Groom Lake, and thereby admitting that the base exists. He claims that due to the Black Programmes, the workers are suffering terribly, some times even dying from lethal diseases. and according to Turley, 'The Soviets had pictures of it, kids in Nevada play with toys of planes that fly from it, and I've got clients who are dying from it...but it doesn't exist.'

'ALIENS WANT MY BABY' PROBE BY MoD.

According to Eric Morris, director of the British UFO Studies Centre, the MoD is to look at evidence next month, concerning people that claim to of been kidnapped by aliens.

Southampton Evening Echo : 20.12.94 :

'WE WATCHED AS A FLYING SAUCER WENT ZOOMING OVER THE DOCKS'.

Fears that we are being visited by beings from another planet are growing - with yet another sighting of a mysterious flying object over Southampton.

Gillian Hunt, of Dale Valley Rd, Shirley, was startled to see a strange spinning black disc hovering in the sky near her home at lunchtime on Sunday.

'It was black and it was oscillating, like a plate spinning on the top of a stick. We watched it for about 30 or 40 seconds before it disappeared in the direction of Southampton docks'.

Mrs Hunt watched the mystery craft through binoculars with her son and daughter, Sarah Macdonald.

Sarah, 18, said 'It was a disc shape and it was hovering. I really haven't got a clue what it was.'

Mrs Hunt added : 'I was sceptical about UFOs before this but you have to keep an open mind'.

The sighting is the latest in a series over the city - although most have been strange lights in the sky rather than daytime sightings.

One report even came from the same road as the latest close encounter.

Just a week ago teenager Katherine Hewitt, 18, said she nearly crashed her car when she saw seven oval lights in the night sky as she drove along Dale Valley Road.

UFO expert Paul Fuller called the latest sighting 'Intriguing'.

Mr Fuller, a founding member of the British UFO Research Association, said : 'About 90 per cent of reports are of nocturnal lights so this is unusual. It is also strange to have two in the same area.'

Shirley police said they had received no other reports of mystery lights.

Schofields Quest : 20.11.94 :

A five minute section that featured Philip Mantle on the Yorkshire Moors (Looking rather wet ! and a bit cheesed off), people who claim to of seen strange lights over the moors. I wouldn't bother with this as it was a waist of 5 minutes in my view.

Horizon : 28.11.94 :

This featured Dr Susan Blackmore (She of the disbeliever scientist faction),who went to America to research the Abduction phenomena.The program featured alleged abductees and people like Budd Hopkins.I thought that the program was very tongue in cheek on Dr Blackmore's part,and although at the end,she appeared to think that there maybe something in the phenomenon,I cannot help but wonder,why she had to go all the way to America,as there are a number of abduction cases in this country that defy the laws of reality.A nice try Horizon,but it fell a bit short of expectations I am afraid.

Strange But True : 9.12.94 :

On the other hand,Strange but True was a fascinating look at the Rendlesham Forest UFO encounter in December 1980.the whole 30 minutes was taken up with the subject and was fascinating.It featured two people who claimed to be there at the time,and also colonel Charles Halt,who was the base commander.This was the best program shown on this series,and as the critics said, 'If all the other programs in the series were as good as this one,then the rest of the programs in the series would of been worth watching'...What more can I say...

BBC 2 : 17.12.94 : 4 Hour Special On The Weird And Not So Weird

This 4hr special looking at the weird and wonderful was a bit of a turn up for the books,and started me thinking 'Is this a sign of things to come ?'.It started with a Fortean Review of the year,featuring a segment of UFO segments caught on camcorder.There was an edition of The X-Files that looked at a chap that set things alight just by being near them,and the program finished up with a 40 minutes paranormal debate featuring Jenny Randles.There were also other programs within the 4hrs concerning other paranormal subjects.Worth a look at,and copy of the video is available from the editorial address on the newsletter cover.

GETTING THE BALLANCE RIGHT. (PART 1). G.HARROP.

Last winter I decided to follow the Crop Circle Phenomenon as it unravelled through the summer of '94, and to visit as many formations as was possible and being as near to the Makers as possible. Having visited or seen well over 50 formations, I for one will be paying less attention to them when they return next year, of that I am sure they will! Is this because I am convinced all this years formations were hoaxes, is the Phenomenon dead, was it alive ? was it all a deception, a joke ? That is for the individual to decide, and only for the individual. The information is there if you look, and if you look with an un-biased mind and an open heart, the truth will shine through.

However, not everyone can spend as much time as I have done this year in Crop fields and I would like to give you my impressions of '94 : - The public on the whole, are intrigued by the formations, however they are fed a diet of ridicule and misinformation where 60's pop stars act as authority's on the subject, and a proud hoaxer, Dr Robyn Allen of the self titled WESSEX SCEPTICS has full reign to spew his open mind towards Circles on the Meridian Tv programme The Magic and Mystery Show (10.11.94), boasting he makes many of them while other Circles are made by acquaintances, i.e all this years formations were hoaxes, as were the past 10 years. His opinions go unchallenged by an incredulous interviewer, who rounded off this one sided show by wishing Dr Allen good luck with next year's activities! What a thumbs up for Trespass, damage and further deceit. The Crop Circle issue is a challenge to people's perception of the world they live in. Some look and listen but refuse to believe of a scientific stumbling block and either ignore it, try to laugh it off or for many reasons, simulate the shapes that we call Crop circles. The majority of the formations in Hampshire, Wiltshire, Dorset and Sussex that I visited were, I am sure hoaxed. The quality of some were undeniably impressive and now with a couple of years practice, hoaxers are improving with each new season. There is no way they will stop, not while the real phenomenon persists each year.
