

PRESS :

Southampton Evening Echo : 20.1.95 :

OUT OF WORLD ? A Caterer, at Ocean Village believes he may have witnessed a meteorite last night. The man, 57, said he saw a bright glow, followed by a fiery tail, moving from east to west. In Basingstoke, a resident contacted police to say he had seen a large green object in the sky trailing green smoke.

Southampton Evening Echo : 20.1.95 :

THE SOUTH : A black "Puma" reported to be roaming the Hampshire and Wiltshire border has been sighted for the third time this year. The animal has been spotted on the A36 between Southampton and Salisbury, at the village of West Grimstead and this week a woman claimed she saw it near the scene of the first sighting in Alderbury.

Southampton Evening Echo : 21.1.95 :

CHANDLER'S FORD : A third person has come forward to report seeing a possible meteorite. Judie McIsaac, from Chandler's Ford was about to leave for work at about 6.15am on Thursday when she saw a bright light in the sky. 'It was similar to a headlight, a yellow-white light. At first I thought it was an aeroplane turning around. Then I realised it couldn't be because it had a long tail attached to it and it was coming straight down,' she said. 'It disappeared behind the houses opposite.' The service station cashier thought it was a comet but after reading reports in the Daily Echo about similar sightings she believes it may of been a meteorite.

Southampton Evening Echo : 21.1.95 :

PUMA PRINTS GIVE PAWS FOR THOUGHT : This article looks at the report of unidentified paw prints found at Allbrook, Eastleigh. It was thought that the animal making the tracks, which were about 2 to 2.5 inches across, would not have been bigger than a puma.

Southampton Evening Echo : 24.1.95 :

Southampton Evening Echo : 25.1.95 :

STRANGE OBJECT IN THE SKY (LETTER) : I was interested to read your report in Friday's Daily Echo headed 'Out of World'. In Lyndhurst, on January 18 at 8.30pm my friend and I were thrilled to see a large, bright white and brilliant green object with a fiery tail, travelling at speed. It seemed very large and very near, and disappeared instantly as if it had disintegrated. We thought this was a comet.

Southampton Evening Echo : 27.1.95 :

LATEST SIGHTING OF MYSTERY BIG CAT : Eastleigh's mystery moggy has risen it's puma-like head again - with the second sighting in just two days.

Only last week, police were called to a house in Allbrook when a householder reported seeing a large dark-like cat in his garden.

And just 48 hours later, Bishopstoke pensioner Sandy Legg had the shock of his life when he too met the latest local celebrity - believed to be a Puma.

Mr Legg, of Riverside, was in Bishopstoke Road when the incident occurred on Sunday evening.

He said 'I was just walking along when this animal jumped out of the hedge in front of me - and turned to look at me.

'It only stopped for a second, then it ran across the road into a garden.

'I just couldn't believe it'.

Mr Legg describes the animal as being around four feet long and two feet high, with a jet black coat.

He said 'I knew it was a puma, but I didn't think to be scared - I was too excited'.

The incident is the sixth big cat sighting in the South this month.

The Sun : 28.1.95 :

BA JET PILOTS DUCK AS UFO FLASHES PAST AT 13,000 FT : The article relates the UFO encountered by the pilot of a British Airways Boeing 737 over the Pennines. The brightly lit mystery object, triangular in shape, flashed down the right-hand side of the aircraft.

The Sunday People : 29.1.95 :

I SUPPOSE A QUICK UFO IS OUT OF THE QUESTION ? : OUT-OF-THIS WORLD sex is bringing a heavenly headache to divorce lawyers.

For more and more couples in America are naming the third party as a lover from **OUTER SPACE**.

Jealous wife Debbie Hill claims her husband John is abducted three times a month by UFOs to make the ether move with a sexy alien.

She said 'I am especially upset by the sexual activity resulting in hybrid off-spring.

'What the aliens do is tantamount to rape'.

Another victim called Linda said husband Steve lost his sex drive after she described her extra-Martian affairs with a flying saucer crew.

The marriage-wrecking UFOs are spotlighted in the science magazine Omni.

A scientist said : 'I have seen several abductees divorce.'

TELEVISION :

14.1.95 : SKY ONE : The Extraordinary (AUSTRALIA) :

This edition featured the UFO encounter of Seamus O'farrell, in 1954, that was also tracked on ground radar. An interesting item, that lasted for around 15 minutes or so.

15.1.95 : SKY NEWS : World Wide Report : Russian UFO's :

I thoroughly enjoyed this news item, that looked at a 700 page report recently obtained from within Russia, about Russian UFO encounters. With film footage, interviews with witnesses, it made a pleasant surprise to read about ufology from behind the Iron Curtain.

19.1.95 : BBC 2 : The X-Files. 1 Hr :

This is now available on both BBC 2 (But series soon finishes), and on Sky One. This program is the best serialised program around as far as I am concerned (Including Neighbours!) and this edition is concerned with a truck driver that has a close encounter with a UFO, that is after his cargo. Our hero's follow the lorry, to find out that it was carrying an alien !, and they find out that the government was hiding a hideous secret.....For this program, I would give it 11 out of 10 (If that was mathematically possible that is !!!!).

22.1.95 : CHANNEL 4 : Communion (The Film) : 2 Hrs :

Based on the book by Whitley Streiber and the book of the same title, the film explores the personal encounters claimed by Whitley Streiber. Having read the book, and seeing how the film exaggerates the book, it is one of those films that I feel that if it happened how it is portrayed, then Whitley is either a good story teller, or he is a brave man to relate his experiences. But we must remember, he is an author of fictional books and has a very active imagination. The film had some great effects, but a little slow in parts. If you asked me for a rating, then I rate it as 7 out of 10.

30.1.95 : DISCOVERY CHANNEL (Cable Tv) : Beyond 2000 : 10 Mins :

This looked at the crop circle phenomenon in this country and really went over the old ground. Not one I would say to watch, as it did not reach any conclusions, that have not already been reached.

2.2.95 : SKY MOVIES : Fire In The Sky : 2 Hrs :

Like communion, this is based on the book about the Travis Walton abduction. I had heard rumours that this film also stretched the truth a bit, but saying that, the effects were very good, and I found it compelling to watch to the end. If this story, like Whitley Streiber's book/film really took place, then watch your back folks, because it could be you next. I would personally give this film a 9 out of 10, as I thoroughly enjoyed it (But read the books first before you watch the film !!!!).

11.2.95 : SKY ONE : The Extraordinary :

Yet another reconstruction of the abduction of Travis Walton. If you believe the Walton story, read the book, bought the tee shirt!, then you will not learn any more from this I'm afraid. It lasted for around 15 minutes and you would be far better off watching the film.....!

ABDUCTION OR INFECTION ?

The abduction scenario and its various agendas are now generally termed to be real events by most of the ufological community. If this is so then we should ask some very serious questions. One is why is there a genetic agenda to the abductions and also if there is a possibility of, if there is to what extent, damage is being done to the abductees, or as some people call them 'Experiencers'. If you believe in the reality of the abductions then you cannot deny the genetic agenda of these entities. This appears to be ever increasing towards the definite reality of a human/alien hybrid. The participants of this genetic program do not seem to have a choice, and even though the aliens have buried most of the memories of the interstellar rape deep within the subconscious, it is found that they can still fester within the human subconscious causing a wide range of symptoms such as depression and traumatic shock without the abductee even being aware.

We must also examine the question of whether this genetic harvesting damages the host in physical ways. For example are any of the major UFO organisations checking and cross referencing the medical histories of abducted women, for any unusual patterns of medical problems, especially hormone and reproductive problems as this seems to be the aliens main interest area.

One of the earliest cases of abduction The Betty and Barney Hill case involved medical problems,when Barney contracted Genital warts after what appeared to be a suction cup was placed on his genitals.This shows that another area that we need to look at is the question of possible infection through medical examinations by the alien beings.So far I have seen or read no evidence to support the theory that the aliens are using any cleaning procedures before,during,or after the medical procedures.If the instruments used are not sterile then the risk of infection is very real and very dangerous.Many of the reported instruments break the skin and probes are sent internally in to the body,causing the body to bleed and scar.

What about the possibility that the abductee before you in the queue may have had an illness,infection or disease.Is it a coincidence that in the years when abductions by alien beings reach fever proportions that we are under threat from a host of new and deadly diseases of which many are harsh and some even terminal,such as AIDS.

I am not saying that aliens are swooping down and infecting us all with the Aids virus,but the basic reality is that they could unwittingly be helping in the spread of the disease throughout the human population.

The reported autopsys on the alien beings state that the digestive systems and other organ's are atrophied,damaged or diseased.Which would suggest some kind of genetic disorder or probable disease,or widespread illness.

If you were ever abducted would you be willing to go last in the queue,just imagine trying to explain to your partner that it was aliens that infected you with pubic lice,or WORSE !

Would you be willing to take the risk that researchers up unto now have ignored whilst arguing over the reality of the existence of the alien beings.
