10.96 : *The Independent Magazine* :

The article concerns itself with American art galleries who are exhibiting alien art work by those of us who claim to of been abducted and had alien experiments carried out on them. An interesting article that looks at the more artistic elements of Ufology and how through art work people portray their experiences.

26.10.96 : *Daily Mail* : *Mecca of Mystery Honoured.*

For decades, the town has been a Mecca for fans of the unexplained. From all over the world, thousands have travelled to Warminster in Wiltshire to keep vigils on surrounding hills for mysterious lights in the sky. Nearby are the prehistoric stone circles at Stonehenge and Avebury, and more recently crop circles have caused controversy.

Now the town is being declared the UFO capital of Britain, and a plaque is to be unveiled today in the town hall.

Warminster lies on the confluence of two so-called ley lines, which some say is the reason for the strange goings-on. Others put them down to the proximity of Salisbury Plain, home of secret military work.

The award has been inspired by Twentieth Century Fox, which has combined with the West Country Tourist Board to arrange the ceremony presided over by Lord Bath. At the unveiling, the film giant will announce the release date for the video of the alien invasion film *Independence Day*. Ron Morrison Smith of the West Country Tourist Board said: "The area has a rich and fascinating history of mystic links. We want to attract as many visitors as we can, and for Warminster it seems as if that could mean from this world and beyond".

An explosion which lit up the skies over the Hebridean Island of Lewis on Saturday was still unexplained last night. Witnesses thought a plane had crashed, but after a fruitless air and sea search, space debris falling to earth was seen as the most likely cause.

Strange unexplained objects and blinding lights are becoming all too common sight in the skies above Salisbury.

For decades sky watchers have flooded police and television stations with reports of unusual sightings of undefinable phenomena but over the past 12 months these reports have increased and now local experts are demanding an investigation.

The prehistoric stone circles at Stonehenge are long-standing venues for UFO spotters and for years the army town of Warminster in Wiltshire, which today will be named the UFO capital of Britain, has recorded the details of these so-called UFOs as a means of monitoring the increasing paranormal activity.

But Ufologist Jason Dears, 34, of Salisbury says that naming the town Britain's capital of UFO's is not helping the problem, and what is needed is a government investigation as to why sightings are increasing in the area.

The Ministry of Defence would not comment if any investigations were under way.

This was a 4 hour epic of UFO information of which some I was not aware of and I even learnt a thing or two. The Retrieval section looked at recovered Flying Saucers and of course Roswell. The final section that I enjoyed the most looked at Dreamland and Area 51. All in all a great 4hr epic (But in reality by the time you remove the breaks, the total running time is around 3hrs 15 Mins. If you can get a copy from someone who recorded it, then grab it and sit back and enjoy. The only bad point for me, was that Alan Godfrey's alleged abduction/UFO sighting was featured in 3 of the programs !

It was claimed that 2 years prior to his sightings, there had been minor earthquakes in the area and that these could of been the cause along with a kind of ball lighting and the release of energy from the movement of the earth's plates. Although I know little about the subject of *Earthlights*, I can imagine that 'Some' UFO sightings/reports could be put down to UFO sightings, but Kenneth Arnold's sightings... Well I will ponder on that one. (60 Mins).

Well worth adding to your collection, and seemingly, Jenny's outlook takes in the ET section a bit more currently, although comments to her still take YEARS, if EVER, to get a reply to ! Is she hoarding all those stamps ? The Sightings magazine itself lists articles on Chris Grimes abduction, proof of crop circles at last (?), Bonnybridge, the conspiracy theory rears it's head again, more on that Roswell autopsy camera work, etc, etc.. and don't forget that Bristol New Trinity Centre 'all dayer' on December 15th, when the Encounter experience hosts Colin Andrews, Nick Pope, Jenny Randles, Peter Hough, and 'ole Dennis Plumkett of the original Flying Saucer Bureau, I used to belong to that in the fifties ! The mag itself includes another claim, Michael Wolf, this time, of his work at Area 51. An 'amateur Astronomer' tells us why he doesn't believe in UFO's ! (Groan !) and Editor Graham Birdsall takes him, rightly, to task ! Another example of how 'sceptics' never seem to study the material ! that Kent 'near miss' again. Hungarian 'landing' photos. The 1996 British UFO 'wave' in detail. Hampshire 'Triangle' video. Good letters page. How to film that UFO. £1.95 from good newsagents or see unopen files above.

XPOSE ... Guess what 'inspired' this glossy, what I used to call a 'fanzine' in my fanatical days of movie going ! You wanna know about Mulder and Scully, or 'Will I ever marry MY cousin?', and sister magazines like 'Shivers' (Mulder and Scully again !) the latest UFO and such films from the USA... maybe I'm too old for such, suit the teenagers ! £2.50 from shops, published by Visual Imagination.. BOOK REVIEW - ERNIE SEARS.

Filling up the half page left I thought it might be of some interest to mention a new book out by Derek Sheffield, entitled 'UFO. A DEADLY CONCEALMENT'. If you read my last reviews of mags, I mentioned this in passing, as the author has been a guest speaker at one of the UFO groups. With one of those weird coincidences that festoon the paranormal, ten minutes after I'd typed those words my doorbell rang and a parcel had arrived for me. Yes ! 'twas the very book, sent with the compliments of one of my village UFO acquaintances ! The one with the very slim figure and the 'almond' eyes ! No, I haven't figured her out yet !

The book is very interesting for the amount of sheer dogged determination the author has put into it, almost entirely aimed at those Belgian triangle sightings in 1989 - 1990, and the run around he got from the authorities, not, surprisingly, our own seemed to be the worst, including our Post Office, with even recorded delivery letters to various people (including ex President Jimmy Carter) going astray or being returned slit open with no apologies ! Mention of ex MOD UFO spokesman Nick Pope says 'his replies were a plethora of contradictions'... Derek meeting with abductee Maria Ward was also disappointing as she was 'into' the psychic side... nothing wrong with THAT, says yours truly ! Derek even badgered the UN and the European Parliament with his missives, to date no satisfactory reply although I'm in touch with him. The author DOES have the additional 'inspiration' of actually seeing a multi-witnessed 'triangle' in August 1962 near his Kentish home. Denials that our own radars and officials knew 'nothing' of

the Belgian events was not surprising ! When in doubt, or under threat of 'exposure', deny EVERYTHING ! The book is worth the £9.99 asked, and Publishers are Blandford Press.

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SIGHTING REPORT.

The following sighting was reported to me on the 31.10.96 that occurred at 7.30pm on Monday 28th October 1996. The witness was driving on the M3 heading from Winchester towards Southampton. The weather was rather atrocious with heavy rain and very strong wind and not the ideal night to be out in. Through the witnesses windscreen, he saw 3 vertical lights in the dark, miserable sky. They were Red - Green - Red in colour and reminded the witness of a set of traffic lights hanging in the sky. They blinked, firstly the top one, then the green, then the bottom red light and they went through the sequence a number of times. The lights then appeared to 'Bank and move off at high speed towards Eastleigh and that is the last he saw of the lights.

There are a couple of things to this sighting that makes me feel that there is a somewhat more of a down to earth explanation. I have driven along this part of the motorway many a time (I work in Winchester for Hampshire Police), and I have often seen red, green, and white lights over the motorway, as planes fly over heading into Eastleigh airport. On one occasion I thought I had seen my first Flying Triangle, but as the lights banked, the dark shape of an airplane came into

view. As the airplanes cross over the motorway to line up with the landing strip at Eastleigh airport, I strongly feel that this may well of been an aircraft on approach to landing at the airport... An on going investigation... Ed..

UFO LECTURE AT SALISBURY COLLEDGE 14.11.96.

Myself and group member Mr Ernie Sears were asked to do a presentation on behalf of the students union concerning the UFO phenomenon. We arrived in good time and were treated to sandwiches, cakes and coffee. The organiser was a bit apprehensive as to the turnout, as previous lectures/talks had small attendance's. But, as I say, even if only one person turned up, that is better than nothing and for me just talking about the subject and passing on my worldly knowledge to others is all that matters. I did a slide/video presentation (The facilities were very good with a video projector and excellent audio system). Mr Sears talked about his experiences involving the UFO phenomenon over the past 40 or so years. As time fast approached 7.30pm, the auditorium was rather empty (in fact only 2 people filled the auditorium !). By 7.45pm things looked up, there was now 10 people in auditorium ! Bearing this in mind though, the evening went rather quick and those 10 people appeared very interested and at least no one got up and walked out. Rather disappointing in numbers, but as the college is rather a long way from the town centre and not easily accessible by public transport, we were lucky to get 10 people.

THE 1996 OXFORD CONFERENCE - ERNIE SEARS.

A horribly wet and windy Sunday didn't make much difference to the lively and often humorous chit chat on the coach that our enterprising organiser Steve Gerrard had laid on as we nipped along to the splendid Conference Centre north of Oxford, stopping on route for coffee.

A great wealth of stalls displaying the usual magazines, books, cassettes, videos and the like, that enrich Ufology for the dedicated, ample seating, first class sound system, refreshments, and the always interesting chance to chat with fellow enthusiasts, and, more exciting, some of the leading names in the lecture circuits, greeted us as we arrived...

The introduction by Ray Hunt, a qualified pilot, with some 8,000 hours in various aircraft including the RAF, CAA and the British Gliding Association, led into his knowledgeable talk which involved air accidents, near misses etc, the Manchester 1995 'near miss' coming in for special attention. A man who knew his subject at firsthand.

The co-ordinator of the organising body, Contact International, Brian P. James, followed, and as an actual experiencer of unexplained events he was avidly listened to, particularly on anomalous objects that appeared on photographs.

All speakers were allocated 60 mins, and personally I could have heard more from Matthew Williams, who produces THE TRUTH SEEKERS REVIEW, a compelling read indeed. Matthew has been on BBC's 'Out of this World', for example, and is a really determined investigator into those covert underground bases, both here and in the USA. His research has produced some intriguing stuff from our own MOD, a 1965 official letter, filing number given to us, on the attitude then to UFO's, was an eye opener ! A guy we really NEED in our movement.

Nick Pope, probably very fed up with the flu he was struggling to recover from, let alone the 'Britains Fox Mulder' title the media has plonked on him, more or less repeated his standard theme, culled from his three years on the MOD UFO desk, and his book, 'Open Skies, Closed Minds'... which really sums it all up ! Considering the Official Secrets Act, etc, Nick has, I think personally, got away with a lot of pungent material.. never mind the doubters who MAY or may NOT have a point or two ! His next book on the Abduction scenario might well open a certain door wider... we shall see ! 'Old hat' some of his lecture and book may be, to many, but looking around at the large younger element at the Conference I still feel Nick Pope is opening a mass of

young, enthusiastic, to hell with authority, minds, all to the good on such a serious matter. Since he asked to include some of my own experiences into his new book, I shall be watching with some interest where the lad is going next!

Roy Lake approached his subject, next, with his usual light touch, that hides a multitude of experiences, after a sighting some forty years ago... beats mine, Roy, by some four years! Chairman of the highly respected LONDON UFO STUDIES GROUP, and featured on many radio and TV programmes, he is now co-working with psychologists and such on regressing abduction and other experiences, some of which participants came forward during his question time.. very interesting, since this is where the whole subject will stand or fall, I think.

Roy Dutton finished the lectures with his usual highly polished and very technical treatise, with illustrations, which left many of us mystified, and, by that time, somewhat yawn prone! With all due respect to Roy, who oddly enough I re-took up an acquaintance with some weeks ago, after a break of some years, he is a master of his pattern involving the 'delivery' of space craft of some kind from larger vehicles into our atmosphere and the 'picking up' of same.. certainly he has proved to ME that my own collection of sightings etc of some years ago fitted his research. Roy retired from the British Aerospace Future Projects Division in 1991. UFO groups information makes it possible for Roy Dutton to predict certain events. He retired from Stockport, I think, to Plymouth, some time ago. A lecturer who knows his stuff and would be best suited to some hi-tech boffins whose minds need to be opened to what is really going on 'up there' or 'down here' !.

With 'question time' aimed at the panel of all speakers, the whole day finished on a positive and lively note.. methinks many, if not all, went away as satisfied as I did, thinking, I trust, 'when is the next one'! Good to see so many young seekers after the truth there... the X files may well be inspiring them but no matter... and the actual sightings reporter there, and the involvement with the 'paranormal', confirm what most of us 'more mature' researchers already know, that the subject is of awesome proportions, and that we must grasp it, encourage our so-called 'betters' that we KNOW the 'Truth is Out there', and we can handle it, traumatic as it may well be! We owe it to future world citizens. Since our current lot have made a right old hash of this tiny ball we cling on to precariously!

That 'something' of momentous proportions is 'going on' seems to be a world-wide phenomenon among us Ufologists, psychists, etc... and the Oxford Conference would seem to confirm this. Your move next! Huh! Should that be 'their move'?

SUFOPIA (PT I).

In an attempt to promote SUFOPIA, I will be writing articles for this magazine on a monthly basis. I am writing these in the hope they will be informative as well interesting as SUFOPIA aim to educate people on the subject of UFO's but in a way that will interest them, not just drone on about facts and figures.

I will start by giving you an example of what has been said by various people regarding UFO's. These aren't the usual witnesses to UFO's that people so often claim need psychiatric treatment if they really believe that they saw what they claim to have seen, but reports made by people who, if they do need this treatment are in a very strange position of power.

I will be including more of these every month because there are far too many to place into a single article.

In conclusion to a July 1947 FBI/Army Intelligence study report, the following was stated: 'This flying saucer situation is not all imaginary or seeing too much in some natural phenomenon. Something is really flying around'.

Of course, July 1947 is regarded by many to be one of the most important months in modern day Ufology, but this report had nothing whatsoever to do with Roswell (honest !). Talking of Roswell though, Major Jesse Marcell gave an interview regarding being the first at the scene of the crash site in 1947, the interview was made in 1979, he states :

'It was definitely not a weather balloon or tracking device, nor was it any sort of plane or missile. It was something I had never seen before. It certainly wasn't anything built by us'.

Dr Bruce Maccabee was a U.S. Navy physicist, in a paper he wrote the following : 'The Air Force knew by the middle of July 1947 that saucers were real and not man made, the technology represented by the (recovered) disc was so far beyond our own that it could not be understood immediately. Therefore it would be necessary to treat the disc as a military secret. This would mean containing all information about it within some small group'.

As you can see, if these people were in need of treatment, America has a lot to worry about !

READERS ARTICLE - MR BARRIE WRIGHT.

I recently read an article in a UFO special magazine about the Apollo Astronauts..... Which I presume most people read, in that it stated there are people who say the moon landing never happened.

I don't often write letters in to UFO related magazines, but being a teenager old enough to appreciate history in the making , I lived and breathed the moon landings, collecting all I could, and never missing a minute of aired news and 'live' coverage.

U.F.O.S CROP CIRCLE FORMATIONS AND THE PARANORMAL.

(SUBTITLED - THE SECRETS RUN OUT. AS TIME RUNS OUT)

The cover of this video has the title U.F.O.s in bold red letters and crop formations in much smaller Letters, no doubt aiming for the more numerous UFO enthusiasts than the cerealogist among us, while the picture cover depicts an alien head with the magnificent Barbury Castle crop formation behind it along with a F.B.T (Flying Black Triangle) and Stonehenge. Its contents however are far less exciting. The three from Andover comprising of Colin Andrews, Busty Taylor and Reg Presley air the same old tales that can be found in books and videos these three have taken part in over the years. These three from Andover in Hants, the 'A' team I will call them, come out with stories such as the U.F.O incident at Alton Barnes in 1992, Busty's find in a crop circle of quote 'Interesting strange jelly substance' (Technical stuff this !) and Joyce Bowles and Ted Pratt's encounter at Chilcomb, near Cheesefoot Head in 1976 and Colins first experiences with crop circles etc etc. Reg points out that weather balloons in the days of the Roswell crash were made from the same material as condoms. I ponder on this pointless information for 10 seconds and move on.
