EDITORIAL.



There are many books currently doing the rounds regarding UFOs and aliens, most of them stating that they have the 'answers', that they know what is behind the UFO mystery, here is another book which claims to at the very least, hold some 'insight' as to what truly lies behind the age old mystery of why the 'aliens' are here, their purpose, and ultimately their place in today's UFO climate. This book looks at not only the UFO abduction phenomenon, but also the possibility that certain Governments of this world actually are in some kind of collaboration with these 'aliens', more so the American Government, of whom the author states, that the U.S. Government may intend to use some 'alien' technology that they have recovered over the years.

The author also looks at contactees throughout the ages, in particular the late George Adamski who claims to have met aliens in a Californian desert back in November 1952, he also looks at the claims made by Bob Lazar who claims to have seen 'alien' craft in an American base back in the 1980's. What is pleasing to this reviewer, is the fact that the author also looks at our

own technology and those strange devices that currently overfly our air space. Most of these, to the unsuspecting public, look fairly similar to many of the UFOs that are currently being reported throughout the world.

The author also touches upon ancient civilizations and the strange objects that they themselves reported in the skies. It's clear to see that the UFO phenomenon has been with us now throughout time itself, a fact that the author so rightly mentions. The reader is also given a run down of the more commonly reported aliens that have been seen from the small greys, to the more hideous creatures that have terrified those unaware. Although I found much in this book that I've read before, the author has his own opinions as to what is going on, and I won't spoil it for him by giving the game away here, suffice it to say that one may find in this book a significant amount of 'new material' which is a rarity these days, with numerous authors covering old ground. Whilst I agree, that one must touch upon cases that have went before, in as much as we must carefully study them to see if there are any similarities, too much of an 'old thing' can be tedious. Thankfully, Raymond's book covers much relevant and important issues, and in a step aside from the more current books available on the market today.

All in all Raymond's book adds to the growing weight of evidence and testimony which is currently gathering throughout the world today, and as such, should be read by believers and skeptics alike.



REVIEWS BY STEVE GERRARD
FROM 15th Aug - 15th Oct 1998.

19th August :

Ch 5 - Brazilian Aliens.

This was a very interesting item that looked at aspects of aliens in Brazil including a look at such creatures at the Chucabara and other alien encounters in this part of the world. A well put together item and one to be seen and may well be screened at a forth-coming group meeting.

8th September :

Ch 4 - The Big Breakfast : Features Steve Rider and Totton College.

Group member Steve Rider was whisked up to London at some ungodly hour (I think it was around 4.30 a.m. !!) to appear on the program and talk about the Totton college course on UFO's. Although the interview took place outside in the rain (There was even a secret hand shake between the presenter and Steve), well done Steve, you came over very well and a credit to UFOlogy.

13th September :

The Why Files : UFO filmed over South London. Features Roy Lake of UFOs.

This was a short, but sweet item of around 10 minutes including an interview with my good friend Roy Lake. The footage was not clear, the

usual light in the sky job, but it is good see that alleged UFO's are still being captured on home video.

24th September :

The Why Files : UFO over Headington, Oxfordshire.

This involved interviews with local UFO experts who spoke about recent sightings over the area. Again, short and sweet, but a good little item to fill up the end of a tape.

5th October :

Sky TV : UFO's - The Best Evidence.

This was the usual cable television repeat, but, it was well worth watching a second time round. It showed a collection of some of the best UFO footage from around the world. One to be shown at a later SUFOG group meeting.

The Why Files : UFOs Over Woolwich.

We all have our own views, ideas etc, and if someone doesn't believe me, well, so what, no skin off my nose. And as for those who make light of the subject (Even those of you involved in the subject..) so what, what will be will be... And as the article finishes 'On the surface, Ernie remains - as he puts it himself - a state pensioner on income support, living in quiet anonymity in a retirement flat'.

'A pretty effective disguise, in fact, for a man with a message from the universe'.... Need I say more... Pity the group didn't get a mention.... Oh well, you can't win them all.

DAILY TELEGRAPH of August 4th has full page feature on the ladies X-

True that my intake and connections are confined to the less lurid papers... no doubt the Sun and the News of the World etc. will have found items to dazzle their readers with !

A couple of late entries....

Southampton Evening Echo of 23rd September ran an article about a UFO group that wants to convert a former RAF base in the New Forest into a refuge for local residents should the little green men invade earth. The group (Un-named in the article) have approached a developer of the site at Sopley Camp, Bransgore for the 100 buildings to be an assembly point for some 1,000 people.... The group, who share information on UFO sightings, believe an invasion is possible and wanted to plan ahead according to the article. I would like to know who this information sharing group is and secondly, can I book a bed with an on

Woolston UFO Talk... By Ernie Sears.

Booked for an hour talk on UFOlogy at the Woolston based Ladies Group I arrived twenty minutes early for my 8.00 p.m. start and was shown to a room by a "friend" and told the group members would arrive shortly.

By 7.55pm I'd arranged all the chairs and tables and unpacked my briefcase and notes etc. Deciding I'd find out what was happening I walked along the passage to the next room where a roomful of people were awaiting my arrival !.....

Quickly under way I managed to hopefully stun the 15 or so ladies who had a trio of men "allowed" there... they washed the cups etc. later !

Tracing my involvement with UFOlogy from 1947 to the current times and thence onto my own experiences, beginning of course with a brief account of Kenneth Arnold's (1947) sighting in the USA, I emphasized the two attempted interceptions by RAF fighters I'd witnessed in 1960 and 1978, immediately denied by the authorities. Throwing in my initiation as a "healer" after some close encounters in 1977 and 1978 and my later "recovered memories" of more encounters in childhood and later, the memories that surfaced in 1995 to 1997 probably made the audience boggle en mass ! Finishing with diplomatic and veiled suggestions that we are all responsible for the world we cling to and unless we did something about the state of it those "doomsday warnings over successive centuries might, just might, have some authenticity" !

Adding advice to watch that immense meteor shower due that night, 8th October, as they left after 10.00 p.m., I suggested that if one such meteor stopped and swooped towards them, to run like hell !

SUFOG members might do well to remember that such small efforts to bring knowledge to the masses add up to something more than all the official and commercially inclined efforts, so why not think hard about attacking both the current apparent apathy and the apparently still ongoing "official" sources of denial ?



SKYWATCHERS is the magazine of the Cornwall UFO Research Group and for some reason I have TWO issues here... 20 and 21 ! Since the first is not the last SUFOG mag here goes ! Interesting article by Dionne Jones on Striebers "Secret School" and Dionne poses some intriguing questions on the book and video. Fortunately (?) he also claims alien experiences which I think is the most IMPORTANT element in ANY reviewers outlook since it is surely UNDENIABLE that such an event changes ones life forever ! Either subtly over many years or dramatically in seconds ! Nigel Wright's interesting June talk at CUFORG covered, the Woodbury Triangle incident, Dionne Jones again with coverage of the "Big Cat", alien implants, a fairy (!) sighting, a "Jelly Man" (!), A good sightings section from Kent, Egypt, Spain, & Cornwall ! Elaine Darlington's always good articles, "Other Intelligence's" by Edward Joseph, a 1977 sighting and the Fortean Times Unconvention. Issue 21 is also good.. more from Ealine Darlington, the groups meetings, World UFO reports, etc. but by FAR the most gripping and DISTURBING is Strieber's latest "encounter" in June 1998 in a Toronto Hotel room which needs a lot of pondering over ! Disturbing to your's truly.. and you ?... since, in this interview by Michael

Lindemann, Strieber has different views on it all, and includes the enforced consumption of a repulsive drink, now and in the past as a child too, which a recently viewpoint (she knew little or nothing about my UFO deeper interests then) as a childhood memory of a "gypsy cure" for whooping cough ! Coincidentally (?) in that very same week I watched the admittedly film of Travis Walton, "Fire in the Sky", where a dreadful jelly like substance was forced down his screaming throat !



Well, that is your quota for this issue ! Probably asking for trouble but any comments on this section welcome, good or not !


A Meeting with Albert Budden. M.Robinson.

Encounter with the unknown
Tom (Group member) & Julie

As time go's by I thought it would be good to write down some of the experiences that have occurred during our time investigating the world of UFOs and associated phenomena. I have always threatened to write some stuff for the SUFOG newsletter, well here it comes !!

As a keen skywatcher Julie and I have spent a great deal of time in and around the Avebury area North Wiltshire. It was here we looked at the great Alton Barnes pictogram of 1990. I already had an interest in UFOs since my brother used to visit Warminster back in the early 70's this being a time when the town was humming with stories of UFO encounters spiral

marks in crop fields, even the odd alien entity and UFO landing. His involvement with local author Arthur Shuttlewood had over the years had filtered down some interesting information which can be directly associated with some of the stories and events happening today, maybe I will be able to express these more fully at a later date.


At this time I would like to give an account of as Allen Hynek would say "High Strangeness". In those Wiltshire hills.

In 1993 many conventional UFO sightings had began to flow as the summer season got under way. For instance, on the evening of Saturday 18th June a large orange ball appeared directly above Woodborough Hill and was witnessed by various individuals, including crop watcher Paul Vigay. It was also videoed from an elevated position on Knapp Hill by Paul Damon Parsons (formally of the South Wales UFO group) !.. By all accounts the glowing light was in view for so long that those viewing the phenomenon were forced to assume it was probably a hoax of some kind whether this is so may never be determined. There was however another more important sighting on Woodborough Hill during the late evening of Tuesday 19th July. On the evening concerned, Julie now my wife and I had decided to spend the night skywatching from the summit of Woodborough Hill. It was a good vantage point and as it was on private land I knew it would not be frequented by crowds of people. Indeed, we found ourselves alone. Video camera by our side in case of anything unusual.

As the night drew in, we gazed Northwards across the expanse of the East field, it was a fine clear night, although a little cold, with a wind rising we moved to a sheltered position facing... (Cont page 17...)

the small clump of trees crowning the Southern extremities of the hill, a distance of around 50 meters from our position and during casual conversation something strange occurred. At around 23.10 we were stunned to see a large dark cherry red glow emerge into view within and to the left of the copse of trees in front of us. Almost as if being inflated by an unseen source, the object grew in stages with a series of pulsation's until it had reached the diameter of a large oak tree. It seemed to exhibit a solid shell-like surface like we had never seen. After six seconds or so Julie shouted use the video, quickly trying to power up the recorder at the moment the video camera powered up it was like the object had detected the cameras power source and rapidly started to collapse until it could no longer be seen. Taking courage I ran towards the position of the object, negotiating a barbed wire fence. I stood facing the trees, a strange sound filled my head, it was not like an audible sound but more like a high electrical hissing or sound of discharge. Gradually even this started to disappear. I was left gazing into the open landscape my heart still pounding from what we had seen. In my mind I went over all possible logical solutions, flares, balloons or any known natural occurrence that could account for what we had seen. It had been the extraordinary cherry red color and dark defined shell of the aerial phenomenon that amazed me although self illuminated it did not project light. I feel that what we had seen had existed on the very fringes of the infrared range of the EM spectrum at a lower frequency we may not have seen it at all. Another aspect to this encounter is the way in which the object had vanished almost as if the act of switching on the camera had alerted it to our presence, who knows what may

have fully materialized if I had not done this.



At first light the next morning a new crop circle had appeared in the East field this being called the Eye formation, although generally it was considered to be a hoax many strange things occurred in and around that formation, one of which being a spinning compass which I had placed at the middle of the formation during my survey of it !!

CROP CIRCLES - FROM NEWS - BOREDOM.



The crop circle phenomenon over the years has inspired books, video's, magazines and a world wide press coverage second to non. But over the years, the phenomenon has steadily declined and the general publics interested has waned to say the least. As you can see from the above graphs, so has the press coverage. In the early 80's crop circle articles in the press steadily grew in number, with a peak of 66 articles in 1989. Then suddenly, crop circle reports exploded, with 515 reports alone in 1990/1. Why ?

(I must say, that so far in 1998, I have only received 3 press cuttings up until the end of June...). One of the main reasons for the explosion was the Doug and Dave fiasco. The 2 old men who wondered around the countryside whilst their wives thought they were down the local for a quick half... The crop circle phenomenon is becoming a thing of the past with not only the press becoming less interested (I understand, that the Portsmouth News, were not aware of the large formation that appeared alongside the M27 in July !, although it was hard to miss). As for me, well I've said it before and I'll say it again, the crop circle phenomenon is just over-grown boys out for a laugh and need a bigger canvas to create their masterpieces on and as for those who are making the money from the phenomenon (£50 for a photo to appear in a newspaper !), they have a lot to loose if the phenomenon dies a death..... UFO and ET Encounters in 'Astral Realms'.

Recently I have had the opportunity to work with an 'experiencer'. ho we'll call Peter. Here, his experiences are recalled, and for the benefit of the reader, those in the astral realms are noted by parenthesis, i.e. [Peter]

In recent years, Peter has had increasing experiences in astral realms, and these have included encounters with ET visitors. Peter is keen to emphasize that his accounts should not be taken as those of publicized 'abductees' or 'contactees', but then where is the line to be drawn between a true contactee, and the abductee ? It is becoming increasingly clear that 'alien abductions' do occur, but in most occurrences will not be of the physical body.

It should be said that Peter is not happy with the term 'abduction', since it is highly probable that while astral bodies are 'taken' by other beings, it is not abduction against the person's will - the 'monitoring' by other beings is with that spirits consent before they came into their physical incarnation, it is just that the conscious mind has forgotten its purpose here. I have yet to come up with a suitable term to describe these encounters, as 'monitory' sounds silly.

We realize that this type of encounter is a very deeply spiritual area, and the concepts will be very uncomfortable for many people, 'abductees' and researchers alike, but all concepts must be explored. We cannot move forward if we keep restricting our concepts and beliefs to extremely narrow paths. If there are differences between actual physical encounters and astral encounters, do the simple terms of CE3K to CE5K suffice ?

Before we try to cover areas of Peter's experiences, we must first provide some background thoughts.

Peter was brought up with the normal religious 'indoctrination' that was part of the education system in this country, but never accepted the ideas of Christian teachings, so was not, in the conventional sense, a religious person. That is not to say that he was an atheist, but more of an agnostic, and explored his own path(s). Therefore, when he became consciously aware of aspects of his astral encounters, he did not find it easy to come to terms with the deep spiritual implications. It was not until he started to become aware of his past, and future incarnations, that the whole picture slowly began to emerge.

One fact that should be considered by the readers at this early point is that a being's 'spirit' is truly universal. It is wrong to describe it as the 'human spirit' - many spirits may be 'earth-bound', but they will not always have human incarnations. [Peter] is well aware that few of his past live have been here on Earth, and he still feels apart from the 'earth-bound' spirits here. [Peter] is, in the strictest sense, a visitor here. [Peter] also knows that he is not alone in being a 'spiritual visitor', there are others here as temporary residents, and they are drawn together in their human forms. It may be of interest for readers to consider why some spiritual visitors here are regarded as 'alien' while others are regarded as 'angels' - what is the difference, perhaps it is down to people's basic beliefs ?

Another aspect of the spiritual realm is that mankind's conceptions of time are totally false. They serve as a barrier to mankind's development, but whether this barrier is self-imposed....

or imposed by higher beings for mankind's own protection right now is not clear - perhaps more information will come, I was going to say "In the future", but that too is a human misconception of linear time. The spirit has the ability to transcend any point of 'time' or space. Therefore the spirit has the ability to have a 'past' physical incarnation here on Earth, or anywhere else in the universe, in the past, present or future, equally its 'future' can be in the past, present or future - it should be remembered that since the spirit can span time, it can also have multiple, or concurrent incarnations in any part of mankind's 'linear timeline'.

We should also consider the different forms of 'astral being', or at least those used by the spirit.



As any of you who travels as the astral self will know, there are many levels of astral being that we can attain, sometimes referred to as being between 'light' and 'heavy', but perhaps 'density' might be a better term. These range from the light, almost ghostly, ethereal forms, right through to the densest, when the astral body is as solid as the physical one. While it is in this densest form, the astral body can suffer injuries and traumas, which are then reflected, or mimicked, back on the physical body - perhaps the two bodies are almost symbiotically connected ? These

mimicked injuries and marks are a very important point to remember when we consider bodily marks suffered by 'abductees'. However, in these forms, the astral body still retains the shape and form of its 'host', whether that is animal, human, or of course 'alien'. When the spirit transcends these lower astral realms, it sheds any connection to a physical form, and becomes a true 'free spirit', which is amorphous, and the feeling is totally different - as one fellow traveller puts it "...like just being a pair of eyeballs moving through space.."

It might be worth considering the concepts of astral realms. To most people, these conjure up images of spiritual realms, with higher beings. However, current science is already working with concepts of their dimensions, and even now speculate on at least ten other dimensions to our own - could these be the same as astral realms ? Since 'we' are able to travel to other astral realms in time and space, then we must accept that other beings will have mastered this technique, and could be traveling here with just as much regularity.

Having briefly looked at backgrounds to experiences, where to start with accounts ? Peter was aware of certain experiences with other beings at an early age, and openly talked about them to his parents, but they were dismissed as 'dreams' or 'nightmares' that children have - how many of you have had similar experiences that were dismissed in the same way?
