
formations in the united kingdom, 2 in Germany, 1 in Israel and 1 in Chile.

GROUP MEETING 18TH APRIL 1999.

What can I say... I would like to say a number of things, but I do not think I could publish it without offending someone. Bill Smith, Steve Rider and myself put a lot into the group and for what... This is the type of support we get. As one of us said, "if you the group member do not like what we agree on, then tough". You have your chance to come along to the meeting for discussion, video, audio material etc. etc. So, after returning to my house, the meeting went ahead as follows :

- SUFOG building society balance : £230.39. 48 Subscribers to the newsletter.
- Car boot sale : I myself attended a 2 hr car boot sale on behalf of the group and raised **£28.50** less £3.00 for the pitch and £2.00 for my refreshments. Total monies raised : **£23.50.**
- **Avebury trip** : Numbers required to editor **by the 30th June. 2.** The cost will be £5 per person. **3.** Steve Rider is hiring a 16 seat mini bus. **4.** We will take water, kettle and a water heater for hot drinks. **5.** You will have to bring your own tea bags, coffee, milk, sugar, food (we will buy 3 large disposable barbecue's if you wish to bring something to cook). **6.** We will leave at 5 p.m. 31.7.99 from Church Road Community Centre car park and return to this point at around 5 p.m. on the 1st August. **7.** We will visit Avebury Stone Circle and Silbury Hill and hold an all night sky watch in the locality. **8.** For Sunday lunch we will go to a local pub (You will have to pay for your own meals and drinks).
- Myself, Ernie Sears and group representative Steve Rider appeared on **3 Minutes** a local TV program to publicise the group. We do not know when it will be screened, but we will show it at a future meeting.
- Next Group speaker will be Ernie Sears lecture on **May the 23rd** at the Church road hall.
- Speaker for June has been cancelled due to lack of response at previous meetings and the next speaker will not be invited along until after the **1999 Conference** in October.
- Busty Taylor's Talk : Only **14** people attended and we raised **£25** for the group.
- London Trip : We may arrange a mini bus trip to London for one of the BUFORA lectures on a Sunday afternoon from 2 p.m. - 6 p.m.. Details at a later date.
- It was voted 3 - 0 that we change the venue for our Sunday night group meetings and we will be now holding our meetings in a Working mans club in Netley (With our own private bar).
- **Conference 99** : Bill Smith, Steve Rider and myself are to arrange a day to go and look at the venue and to make one or two plans as regards to tables etc for book, video sellers etc. Bill Smith is currently working on selling advertising space in the program with local pubs, shops etc. I have printed 100 tickets, I will hold 70, Bill Smith holds 10 and Steve Rider has 20. Advertising is in hand and Ernie Sears is going to approach a friend to see if they can design a poster. So far, we have tables for Quest International merchandise, SUFOG merchandise and Totton College UFO course. I am going to approach Forbidden Planet in Southampton and UFO book dealer Lionel Beer to see if they would like a table. We still have a few jobs to do : book the hotel for the speakers, taxis to and from the venue for speakers (Steve Rider has this in hand), and Sunday lunch. Also, we have to also buy the raffle prizes nearer the time. We also decided that I should produce 15 videos and 15 audio tapes to sell on the day costing the group £40.32. We stand to

make around £131.68 profit. These will be from past speakers at our Sunday afternoon events.

We finished the meeting at around 10 p.m. with a video that I was thinking about showing at the group meeting, but Bill and Steve certainly did not miss out seeing this brilliant UFO filmed over China in 1999 (I may show it again at a future meeting). So, as usual, we lost money from our Sunday evening meeting : 3 people = £6.00 subs... Hall hire = £13.00.. Total loss to the group : £7.00. If anyone has any second hand UFO material i.e. books, magazines, videos, audio tapes etc that they would like to donate to the group to sell at the conference, please let the editor know.

First crop circles of 1999.
(I.R.C.U.P 1999 Crop Circle Database).

1. Reported 11.4.99 - Newton St. Leo Nr Bath : A large circle with 2 smaller circles with a ring around one. Somerset. Oil Seed Rape.
2. Reported 12.4.99 - N.East or Marlborough : Rather sloppy looking triangle formed from two dissected circles with a key-type path on one side. Wiltshire. Oil Seed Rape.
3. Reported 12.4.99 - Gravesend, Nr Rochester : An elaborate formation that appears to be made of some 12 interlocking circles in a circular shape. Appears on the ground to be an obvious hoax, with much damage. Kent. Oil Seed Rape.
4. Reported 16th April - Milk Hill, Nr Alton Barnes : Large circle with one ring to the North and another to the South. No visible tracks, but circle appeared to be about 8 days old when found, due to extent of crop growth. Wiltshire. Oil Seed Rape.
5. Reported 15th April - Bishop Canning, near Devizes : A large ring with a flattened segment of circle forming an irregular vesica pisces, with a small grapeshot on one side. Wiltshire. Oil Seed Rape.
6. Reported 19th April - Over Wallop, near Andover : Early 1990's style pictogram, aligned along a tramline. Hampshire. Oil Seed Rape.
7. Reported 19th April - Everleigh, near Pewsey : A large ring with a flattened smaller circle inside, touching the outer perimeter. Wiltshire. Wheat.
8. Reported 27th April - Hen Wood, near West Meon : A circular ring surrounded by three segments of standing crop within a larger circle. Hampshire. Oil Seed Rape.
9. Reported 30th April - Woodborough Hill, Nr Alton Priors : A circle with some rather irregular 'bars' within it. It looks like a rather amateur hoax. Wiltshire. Oil Seed Rape.
10. Reported 3rd May - Several overlapping circles in a long line, each portraying a partially overlapping disc. Kind of symbolic of the forthcoming eclipse ! Hampshire. Oil Seed Rape.
11. Reported 3rd May - Milk Hill, Nr Alton Barnes - A strange shape consisting of multiple circles arranged around a central circle with two outer circles. Wiltshire. Oil Seed Rape.
12. Reported 9th May - Tormarton, Nr Chipping Sodbury - Ringed circle, visible from the M4. Somerset. Oil Seed Rape.
13. Reported 24 May - Toot Balden, Nr Oxford - Single circle, possibly 2 -3 weeks old. Oxfordshire. Oil Seed Rape.
14. Reported 24th May - Toot Balden, Nr Oxford - A large ring about 15' thick, approx. 100' dia. There is a small key-like appendage added to it. Oxfordshire. Barley.

Mind you, the program presenters stated that it was a waste of time, and that it was just people walking around the fields using a plank and rope. Need I say more... !!!!

The Daily Mail : 27.4.99... Riddle of a Silver UFO 'the size of a battleship'...

CONSPIRACY theorists had a field day yesterday over reports that a UFO 'the size of a battleship' had been spotted 28,000 ft above the North Sea. Both the Civil Aviation Authority and the Ministry of Defence confirmed they were aware of the alleged sighting but denied they were investigating it.

"This may sound silly," said the CAA, "but it is a matter for the MoD".

The MoD commented, "Our people have been looking at it but we are not investigating".

One UFO spotter declared : "Well, they would say that, wouldn't they?".

The mysterious craft - said to be silver-coloured & pencil thin with square windows along the fuselage - was reported by a pilot on a private charter flight between Linkoping, in Sweden and Humberside on February 3.

The pilot, from the Luton based airline Debonair, was flying a BAe 146 jet off Denmark when the cockpit was immersed in 'incandescent light'.

A CAA spokesman said 'He saw an unidentified bright light below the aircraft. The area was illuminated for ten seconds.

'Three other aircraft reported seeing it moving at high speed, or static. As far as we are concerned, the matter is closed'.

Debonair refused to name the pilot. 'He is on four days leave,' said a spokesman. 'He definitely saw a bright red light'.



15. Reported 23rd May - Avebury Trusloe - A very elaborate pictogram with many curved paths and individual circles. Wiltshire. Barley.

16. Reported 23rd May - Compton Dando, Nr Bristol - A ring with what appears to be two crescent shapes inside it. Somerset. Barley.

17. Reported 28th May - Two overlapping circles with the whole formation approx. 90 ft across. One circle is approx. 30 ft in dia and the other 70 ft. Essex. Oil Seed Rape.

18. Reported 10th May - Cockfosters - Single circle approx. 30 ft dia. Hertfordshire. Oil Seed Rape.



19. Reported 28th May - Owlesbury, Nr Winchester - Single circle with three equidistant smaller satellite circles each approx. 50 ft dia. Hampshire. Wheat.

20. Reported 26th May - Thurleigh, Nr Bedford - A single Circle. Bedfordshire. Oil Seed Rape.

21. Reported 29th May - Penton Grafton, nr Andover - A nest of crescents approx. 300 ft dia. Hampshire. Barley.

22. Reported 31st May - Upham, Nr Bishops Waltham - 2 curved paths with arrow type designs on them & curved paths each ending in 3 smaller circles arranged in an approx. 'S' shape. Hampshire. Barley.


23. Reported 31st May - Barbury Castle - A Menorah shaped design with an additional ring / crescent shape in the same field. Wiltshire.

24. Reported : 1st June - Upham 2 - 2 rings with a circle inside one & a wavy pattern around the outside. Hampshire.

25. Reported 1st June - Amersham - 2 single circles in the same field. Buckinghamshire. Barley.

26. Reported 2nd June - Barton Le Clay - Circle with standing centre, surrounded by a ring with a path leading to a smaller circle.

27. Reported 7th June - Dewsbury - A largish (100 - 150 ft) circle with a ring around it. North Yorkshire. Wheat.



28. Reported 12th June - All Cannings - circular design with angular segments. Wiltshire. Wheat.


29. Reported 12th June - East Field, Alton Barnes - elaborate pictogram (1020 ft) incorporating many classic crop circle designs from previous years. Wiltshire. Barley.

30. Reported 12th June - East Field 2, Alton Barnes - Pictogram, resembling a South American Sun Serpent. Wiltshire. Barley.

YOUR EDITOR TALKS TO THE WEST END LADIES**GROUP.. 27th APRIL 1999.**

I was invited along to give a talk on the subject of UFO's to a small group of around 20 ladies, lasting for around 1 hour. I arrived at 7.30 p.m. and started the talk at around 7.45 p.m. after a few more people had arrived. But, we spread the word and I think they may well ask me back again next year for another presentation on the subject of either UFOlogy or as a Special Constable, but we will see.



ROSWELL - THE SEQUEL.

Now the military has a new explanation.

The Air Force has declared victory over the aliens. Last week the military released a 231 - page report that it hoped would finally bury the mother of all UFO stories : the Roswell Incident. In 1947 a sheep rancher near Roswell, New Mexico, found a blanket of sticks, tape, rubber, tinfoil and paper that many earthlings believe to be the remains of a flying saucer. The government, which has altered its story a few times, still says that debris came from a device used to spy on Soviet nuclear activity. But the feds have now come up with explanations for some of the weirder observations in the area. What some people thought was a flying saucer was probably a disc-shaped NASA test craft. A creature that looked like an alien - slit like eyes, misshapen face - was really an air force captain injured in a balloon flight. People who saw eerie bodies missing their hair, ears and thumbs had stumbled upon life-like dummies that had been dropped out of planes to test parachutes. The military even said that a plane crash near Roswell in which 11 men burned to death might account for the oft-told story of the army's secret autopsies on mangled, blackened corpses. Never mind that the balloon accident, the dummy drops and the deadly crash didn't occur until the 1950s. "If you find that people talk about things over a period of time," said Col. John Haynes, "they begin to lose exactly when the date was."

UFOlogists say it's the military that is confused. "The air force is trying to pull a fast one," says Stanton Friedman, who has written two books on Roswell. "If they said they had dumped dummies in 1947, I would have raised a very big eye brow - but they couldn't, because no one was doing that then." There's more at stake than the government's word. Roswell has built two UFO museums and a small industry around the 1947 incident. This week the town expects 100,000 tourists to come celebrate the 50th anniversary of the discovery in the sheep field. "People are caught up in a mania," says Walter Haut, a retired army PR officer who believes a UFO landed. "Maybe someday the government will come out with satisfactory information, but some people will never be satisfied. This whole thing has gotten out of hand". Now, there's an alien idea that deserves more exposure.

Crop Circle's and UFO's arrive in Holland...

On the 9th June Art Bell show Linda Moulton Howe played a small segment from crop circle researcher Nancy Talbot who spoke of a recent witness to a circle forming in Holland on the 7th June 1999 at 12.15 am. A man woke and looked out of his window on a very large field adjoining his home. He saw a "small, misty, pinkish-purple light. Not a sphere - more football (American style) shaped - but a little smaller, which was coming in over the field at a height of about 10 feet - maybe 12 ft - over the field, from quite a distance away. It's an enormous field. He watched it as it came closer and closer till it was about 50 metres behind his house" (The witness had had several circles in his field before). The light stopped in the air. "The word he used was 'hanging', then it started to elongate - spread out becoming thinner and thinner looking like a disc. When it was about 3 feet in diameter - still hanging there - it stopped, not moving except for the expanding motion. Then he watched electrical discharges coming from the underside of this disc shaped, misty, pinkish-purple cloud - ball of light - for about 6 to 10 seconds. Then the light phenomenon simply dissipated - gone". He quickly threw on some clothes, ran outside to the spot where the light had been to find a 30 foot in diameter circle with a smaller 10 foot circle nearby, neither had been there at 10 p.m. when he went to bed. Talbot didn't know how to interpret the Dutch witness saying the field is grain, but surmises it could be wheat.



23.5.99 : CH4 TV : Nick Pope.



NEWS RELEASE FROM NICK REDFERN 16.5.99

UFOs, THE OFFICIAL SECRETS ACT & THE JOINT INTELLIGENCE COMMITTEE - A BREAKTHROUGH..

Has the British Government ever employed the use of the Official Secrets Act to silence those implicated in the UFO subject ? To those armchair researchers who proclaim that such an idea is absurd, I say : 'Think again'.

In my first book, *A Covert Agenda*, I presented clear evidence via officially-released documents now available at the public Record Office at Kew, that in both 1953 and 1956 orders were circulated throughout the RAF warning personnel not to talk about the UFO issue outside of official channels ; however, the records which had been declassified at the time I wrote the book did not directly reference the OSA or its potential use from a UFOlogical perspective. Nevertheless, I was also able to present the testimony of a number of individuals (some with media ties) who asserted that OSA had been used to keep the truth surrounding UFOs under wraps.

Via a file that I secured only days ago from the PRO, however, I am now able to prove conclusively that UFOs and the Official Secrets Act go hand in hand. Exactly why the Government has chosen to release this file is a mystery in itself, given that it sharply contradicts past assertions.

The file in question (titled 'UFO Policy') covers the period 1958 to 1963 and revolves around UFO investigations undertaken by various Air Ministry departments during that time frame. Contained within the file as a 6-page document dating from December 1960 and circulated at 'Secret' level throughout the Royal Air Force. Like earlier papers, it details the procedures to be followed in the event that military radar operators, RAF pilots, civil pilots or members of the public should report a UFO.

Interestingly, however, the paper in question contains two eye-opening revelations. First, it states that in situations where UFOs were tracked on radar, any military aircraft in the vicinity were to be diverted from their normal flight to 'investigate the phenomena'. Second, and far more significant, is the Air Ministry's overwhelming desire to prevent the media and the public learning about such

intrusions, trackings and interceptions. I quote from the paper in question :

'The Press are never to be given information about unusual radar sightings. Unauthorised disclosures of this type will be viewed as offences under the Official Secrets Act.'

Although brief in nature, this document (which remained in use until the formation of the MoD on 1 April 1964 - how appropriate) makes it abundantly clear that the UFO issue was indeed covered by the OSA.


On another - but equally important - matter, the file in question also makes a very brief reference to a pre-1959 study of the UFO mystery carried out by none other than the British Government's Joint Intelligence Committee (JIC) !

Certainly, it has long been recognised that at various times since the late 1940s investigations into UFO encounters have been undertaken by the Royal Air Force, the Air Ministry and the Ministry of Defence. However, the revelation that the JIC also carried out an investigation more than 40 years ago is of great significance. Why so ?

First, the membership of the JIC includes not just elite personnel from the MoD, the Treasury and the Foreign and Commonwealth Office, but also the heads of MI5, MI6 and the Government Communications Headquarters at Cheltenham - GCHQ !

Second, the fact that (to my knowledge) no rumours have ever circulated to the effect that the JIC undertook its own UFO investigations programme in the late 1940s or 1950s, is an indication of the level of secrecy that surrounded the project.

The files at the Public Records Office concerning the JIC make no reference to a 1940s/50s UFO investigation ; however, I am now actively looking to resolve this issue via several methods and hope ultimately to reveal further findings at a later date. At this stage, the extent to which any of this may have a bearing on the allegations of direct UFO studies undertaken by GCHQ, MI5 and MI6 both decades ago and in the present day, can only be guessed at.

One of the most gripping and authentic sounding UFO books on the subject I have read in many years. Written in a down to earth style (no joke intended !) with all the attention to detail that one might expect from an ex-serving police officer, right from the authors first actual close encounter in January 1978 while on his Yorkshire “beat”, along with a startled colleague in their police vehicle, to the present day...

Tony Dodd was to encounter many more such incidents, and on retirement put all his experience with the first Crime Task Force during his 1962 to 1988 stint, being seized with an insatiable desire to find “the truth” of the enigma. I'm sure to many of you, Timothy needs little introduction, but just to refresh your memories, and as an introduction to his splendid work, I will run through one or two things he has been involved in over the last 12 years.

First, in 1987, he published his first book "Above Top Secret" (The World Wide Cover-up) which reached number one in the Best Sellers list, and recently, his book has been updated to include many more new U.F.O and related incidents under the title of "Beyond Top Secret" (The World Wide UFO Security Threat).

If you have either of these books on your shelf at home, consider yourself very fortunate, as you will have in your possession one of the most complete and informative volumes ever written on the subject of UFO's and Alien Contact. You will find yourself going back time and time again into the book for background facts and information. If you don't own either of these books, I advise you to pick them up as soon as possible.

Also amongst Timothy's other excellent contributions are "Alien Liaison" (The Ultimate Secret) 1991 "Alien Update" 1993 and "Alien Base" 1998. Sandwiched in between these were the comprehensive "UFO Reports" of 1991, 1992 and 1993. Timothy informed me that the reason the yearly "UFO Reports" did not continue, was that "Alien Update" took over the mantle from them.

Timothy's TV and Radio work has been so extensive, I can not mention all those programs he has appeared on. But in most programs on the subject of UFOlogy, he is usually called on to contribute in some way. As I had known Timothy as an author through reading his books for a number of years, it was with great pleasure that I heard he was coming to "Waterstones" at Above Bar in Southampton to promote his latest book "Alien Base" (Earth's Encounters with Extraterrestrial's). I duly went hot footed to Waterstones to find out more and obtain a ticket to allow me to attend this unique event. I saw this as an opportunity too good to miss and thought if I wrote to Timothy, he may be kind enough to grant me an audience. I did not know whether or not I would receive a reply, seeing as he must be in great demand. But within 3 days, a letter dropped on my doorstep. It was a note from Timothy asking to meet him at the book shop at 18.45, a full 45 mins before his presentation was due to start. Well, at long last, the day arrived and I turned up at the door of "Waterstones" at 18.40. There was no sign of life inside or outside the entrance. Nothing happened for about 10 minutes. Then the manager came to the door and asked if he could help me. I explained that Timothy had written to me and asked me to arrive early so we could have a chat. The manager then said he would check to see if Timothy had arrived and he disappeared back inside the bookstore. A few more minutes wait and he returned, opened the door and said Timothy was waiting for me downstairs.

We shook hands and I introduced myself and after we had chatted for a few minutes, I asked him if he would be so kind as to grant me an interview on behalf of the readers of the SUFOG Newsletter and he agreed.

As the room we were in was being prepared for Timothy's presentation, I asked the manager's if there was another room we could use for the interview and she kindly offered us the facility of the staff managers office on the top floor. So we made our way up in the lift to the office. The atmosphere was much more comfortable and relaxed and ideal for both of us. What now follows is a full transcript of the interview I had with author Timothy Good.

BS : First of all Timothy, welcome to Southampton, and I hope you enjoy your visit here.

TG : Thank you. Unfortunately I won't be staying very long, but it's not the first time I've visited Southampton. My mother's family had a house in the Isle of Wight and I've also done concerts in Southampton with the L.S.O.

BS : Happy memories for you I am sure. If I may start off with my first question. Could I ask you why you think the 'Greys' have emerged as the predominant form of alien being in view of the variety of UFO's seen across the world ?

TG : A good question, and I would answer that by saying are they the most predominant form of aliens seen in recent times ? Some countries do not report Grey bug eyed aliens. The Greys exist, I have no doubt about that. But I don't think they look like those pictured on Whitley Striebers book "Communion". People read Budd Hopkins, David Jacobs, John Mack and Whitley Strieber books, and its very easy for people to get into the frame of mind that they've been abducted by aliens. I think also that we've got to be very careful in the way we use hypnotic regression.

BS : Yes, I've seen programs on TV that suggest people undergoing this treatment may only be bringing forward images they have seen on TV or read about in books.

TG : Exactly. We've got to be very careful. It can be a useful tool, but it should be handled by someone who is medically qualified, and not by those back street abductionists who may only encourage peoples fantasies if they are fantasy prone.

BS : I don't think that hypnosis is always the answer in some cases.

TG : No, I think that people, with time, do recall what has happened to them and I think that that's healthy and that they can deal with it much better. But the bottom line as far as I'm concerned is that people have been abducted. There is no question about that in my mind. But going back to your original question, one of the reasons for writing "Alien Base" is to show that rather than just these bug eyed aliens being seen. There are far more alien species now than is commonly supposed.

BS : UFO sightings have increased steadily over the last few years. Do you think that with the advances in video and photographic technology, UFOlogists are in danger of having even more problems with hoaxes ?

TG : Yes, I think there is a danger of this happening. We see it already with the proliferation of video of lights in the sky. Video cameras must be used properly especially at night. Unfortunately far too many people are filming airships, aircraft lights, and other things at great distance and sometimes the video gives the wrong impression.


BS : The classic one I can remember from TV is the orange diamond shaped UFO, which I believe was caused by an effect created by the camera lens.

TG : That was first shown up in Lawrence Moors documentary "UFO" which he produced, directed and wrote, and I was the consultant on that when we were able to show conclusively that it was the effect of the iris on the video camera, and similar shots have been taken in Russia, but we are dealing with a light source of some kind. So there was something there, but hopefully one day someone is going to get something fantastic on film.

BS : Do you think that Ray Santilli's video of an alien autopsy should be taken seriously.

TG : I think it should be taken seriously, but has anyone actually analysed the supposed 16mm footage. I heard about this film long before it was made public. I tried to contact Ray Santilli on a number of occasions, but my messages and faxes were ignored, and I find that very suspicious. From what I've seen, I could be wrong, but to me it looks as though it was filmed on video. I don't see anything to indicate that it was shot on 16mm film.

In 1947 with 16mm, you would get all sorts of



scratches, flares etc. You can clean these up. I could be wrong, but my conviction is that this film is bogus.

BS : During your extensive research and investigations, is there any one particular case that you think proves the case for alien visitations.

TG : I can't think of any one particular case. It's a multi-faceted subject and it's more a number of cases put together, rather than one that stands out on its own. Someone may have got some good film, another may have been taken on board a craft. All sorts of aspects come into it and it's very difficult for people who've been abducted to prove their experiences. If your talking about proof, proof is unfortunately elusive. I'm sure it's there and that the American's have alien craft and bodies and that possibly limited communication going back over the years to the 1940's.

BS : If Government's continually says UFO's have no defence significance, why are they obviously still taking part in blatant cover-ups ?

TG : I think it's nonsense. They clearly have very great defence significance. If they are invading our air space at will, if we don't know where they are coming from or what their purpose is, if it's not a defence significance, I don't know what is. As Nick Pope has confirmed, there have been many cases of civilian aircraft being involved with near collisions with UFO's. These could have been disastrous and that is surely of defence significance to military aircraft in particular. There have been cases where they have tried to 'lock on' or fire at these UFO's and guidance systems have failed, communications systems are effected, radar is effected. These are serious problems and of course another one is missing aircraft.

BS : Do you believe Bob Lazar's claims that he worked on alien spacecraft at Area 51, given that there is no conclusive evidence to prove he ever worked there.

TG : Bob Lazar has lied about his credentials, he is not a nuclear physicist. There are no records to say he attended colleges or university's that he says he's been to. He has also got a very dubious background which he has been up front about, but in saying that, some things that happened during that time frame indicated to me that he may well have been exposed to something. He is a very talented engineer and may have been brought in as a "maverick engineer" on some unknown project at Papoose Lake, just a few miles from Area 51. A recent MUFON Journal article suggests that there may be reasons for taking some of Bob Lazar's claims seriously. So I think there is something in it.


BS : Area 51 according to records, still doesn't exist. Is it possible that top secret "Black" aircraft projects are being tested there and are they the result of alien technology.

TG : Area 51 has now been acknowledged as being there and the term "dreamland" has now been applied to

describe this place. In answer to the first part of your question, I would say they are definitely still testing and experimenting with "Top secret" aircraft at this place, but some of the craft used there, certainly look to me as if they are. If not extraterrestrial. Attempts to duplicate the technology and I think that is going on. We haven't yet reached the stage where we can fly these things around all over the place. We are testing them very carefully because if one of these things got lost or came down, it would be absolutely disastrous.

BS : Do you think there is any particular reason for the recent spate of UFO sightings in Mexico ?

TG : I have seen hundreds of video's of the sightings in Mexico. Most of them I don't find convincing at all, but obviously something there is genuine. There is no doubt that something is going on. I do mention in my book "Alien Base" aircraft coming in to land at Mexico airport running into the odd



vehicle or small probe and of serious problems with radar and on board computer systems.

BS : Lord Hill Norton recently asked questions in the House about the Rendlesham Forest Incident and was told that nothing of defence significance happened there, when again evidence clearly shows something definitely did happen there.

TG : Something of defence significance clearly did happen there. Bentwaters which had more nuclear weapons stored there than any where else in Europe was nearby and clearly if a craft of unknown origin lands outside two American air bases, it is of enormous defence significance. If not, why then as Colonel Holt told me did a special team come over from Washington and from what I gather from other sources, check the nuclear weapons to see if they were affected by being in proximity of UFO's. It's far too sensitive for the authorities to admit that.


BS : Do you ever feel you are getting so close to uncovering the truth, that deliberate attempts are made to stop or hinder some of your investigations.

TG : Yes. I've never been threatened, but attempts were made in the U.S. to hinder my investigations on 3 occasions going back to the 1970's, where my hotel room was broken into and my research notes were stolen. An on another occasion, all my tickets to fly me around to other locations were also stolen from my hotel room.

BS : Do you think that the films of Travis Walton's experiences (Fire In The Sky) and Whitley Streibers Communion should have been made and do you think they have had a positive or negative effect regarding the case of alien abductions ?

TG : I think both, depending on who is watching it as far as serious researchers are concerned. I find it infuriating in both films, that the actual descriptions are so sensationalised, particularly "Fire In The Sky". The film about Travis Walton, it is nothing like his experiences as he described it, which I find annoying. But that's Hollywood for you.

BS : Timothy, thank you very much for your time.



I would have loved to have had more time to question Timothy, but time was pressing on, and he had to go and give his presentation to a packed audience (More about that later).
