## European FT Initiative.

Calling all UFO Research Groups in both the United Kingdom & on the European Mainland. An attempt to track the black triangular-shaped UFO across Europe during the years 1993 - 1997 is underway. Based upon Project FT's database which contains some 7,000 sighting reports, additional FT reports are required which will be added to the database and which may possibly reveal just where the

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

After coffee and sandwiches by the shore at a nearby waterside village a friend and I walked up the main street, and, oddly, both "fancied a cup of tea" at a little olde world cafe we were passing. entering, I pointed out a table but my friend insisted we used the small back room and so it was where we'd sat in the past and no, I didn't like the chequered tablecloth then either... made my head swim ! I felt just as disorientated this time and we moved to a smaller table near the window. Immediately we were both feeling disturbingly weird... my friend said she was in a dreamlike atmosphere, like a 'bubble'. ### The Nasa Footage is shown.....

Information about the new NASA footage. There is a short preview copy of some of the footage that was seen at Leeds last year at :

During last September's 18th Leeds International UFO Conference, the audience were made privy to news that UFO Magazine had acquired 520 video tapes totalling over 2,500 hours of NASA space shuttle transmissions. These had been recorded and logged by a Canadian TV station manager who believed the footage contained stark evidence of extraterrestrial activity.

Last August, a representative from UFO Magazine and the Australian-based Phenomena exhibition travelled to Canada at the request of this individual. Following a week-long series of meetings, agreement was reached for UFO Magazine / Phenomena to disseminate relevant segments of that footage to the world.

Since then, brief segments of the footage have been screened at the Acapulco Conference in Mexico on 12 December and on a special TV monitors within the Phenomena exhibition in Freemantle, Perth.

Several highly respected figures within the fields of UFO research and SETI have viewed some of the material. The term 'historic' was ventured on three separate occasions. Other highly placed figures within NASA itself, as well as eminent physicists have expressed bewilderment on viewing the footage for themselves.

Considerable international media interest has already been expressed.

We are now to disclose that a timetable for disseminating this material into the public domain has been agreed among the relevant parties. On Saturday, 11 March, Graham W. Birdsall and Russel Callaghan will make a 3 hour presentation on the NASA footage at the 9th Annual International UFO Congress Convention and Film Festival, which is being staged at the River Palms Resort, Laughlin, Nevada (5 - 11 March).

The world's media have been extended an invitation to attend. Their lecture will end at 12 noon (4 am GMT). Back in England, at that

precise moment, a presentation of the NASA material (video / stills / explanation) will be uploaded onto our Webster and made available to the world.

Thereafter, it is anticipated that multinational TV and news gathering institutions will assist in further disseminating this material across the globe.

Further details and background information will feature in the March / April 2000 issue of UFO Magazine, available on news-stands across Britain from 24 February.

**UFO sighting over Basingstoke 3.3.2000.**

As you receive your newsletter, details of a UFO seen over Basingstoke on the 3rd March 2000 have just arrived at the editors address. The sighting looks very interesting indeed and I have posted the witness a questionnaire following a lengthy telephone conversation. The sighting consisted of two rows of lights in a 'V' formation number between 20 - 30 separate objects. I have asked group investigator Steve Rider to take on the case, which he seems happy to do. So, when I receive more information, I will update everyone via the newsletter. This is our first UFO report of 2000 and I just wonder, how many more we will have over the coming months.

Also, the groups yearly report is now available and will sent out with the newsletter probably in April when the next edition of the newsletter will be ready. This will show how the group has progressed over the 12 months from January 1st 1999 - January 1st 2000. In some ways it does not make good reading, but in others, the picture is not all doom and gloom....

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**NASA FACTS...**  
**The US Government and Unidentified Flying**  
**Objects..**

No branch of the United States Government is currently involved with or responsible for investigations into the possibility of alien life on other planets or for investigating Unidentified Flying Objects (UFO's). The US Air Force (USAF) and the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) have had intermittent, independent investigations of the possibility of alien life on other planets; however, none of these has produced factual evidence that life exists on other planets, nor that UFO's are related to aliens. From 1947 to 1969, the Air Force investigated UFO's; then in 1977, NASA was asked to examine the possibility of resuming UFO investigations. After studying all of the facts available, it was determined that nothing would be gained by further investigations, since there was an absence of tangible evidence.

In October 1992, NASA was directed by Congress to begin a detailed search for artificial radio signals from other civilisations under the NASA Towards The Planetary Systems (TOPS) / High Resolution Microwave Survey (HRMS) program (also known as the Search for Extraterrestrial Intelligence project). Congress directed NASA to end this project in October 1993, citing pressures on the US Federal budget. The HRMS did not detect any confirmed signal before it was stopped. However, similar work will continue in a more limited manner through efforts of private groups and through academic institutions. The Search for Extraterrestrial Intelligence Institute (SETI) in Mountain View, CA, effectively replaced the Government project, borrowing the signal processing system from NASA. The SETI Institute is a non-profit corporation conducting research in a number of fields including all science and technology aspects of astronomy and planetary sciences, chemical evolution, the origin of life, biological evolution, and cultural evolution.

During several space missions, NASA astronauts have reported phenomena not immediately explainable; however, in every instance NASA determined that the observations could not be termed "abnormal" in the space environment. The 1947 to 1969 USAF investigations studied UFO's under Project Blue Book. The project, headquartered at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio, was terminated December 17, 1969. Of the total of

12,618 sightings reported to Project Blue Book, 701 remain "unidentified".

The decision to discontinue UFO investigations was based on an evaluation of a report prepared by the University of Colorado entitled, "Scientific Study of Unidentified Flying Objects;" a review of the University of Colorado's report by the National Academy of Sciences; previous UFO studies; and Air Force experiences investigating UFO reports during the 1940's, '50's and '60's. As a result of experience, investigations, and studies since 1948, the conclusions of Project Blue Book were : (1) no UFO reported, investigated, and evaluated by the Air Force was ever a threat to our national security; (2) there was no evidence submitted to, or discovered by, the Air Force that sightings categorised as "unidentified" represented technological developments or principles beyond the range of modern scientific knowledge; and (3) there was no evidence indicating that sightings categorised as "unidentified" were extraterrestrial vehicles.

With the termination of Project Blue Book, the USAF regulation establishing and controlling the program for investigating and analysing UFO's was rescinded. Documentation regarding the former Project Blue Book investigation was permanently transferred to the Modern Military Branch, National Archives and Records Service, in Washington, DC 20408, and is available for public review and analysis.

Since the termination of Project Blue Book, nothing has occurred that would support a resumption of UFO investigations by the USAF or NASA. Given the current environment of steadily decreasing defence and space budgets, it is unlikely that the Air Force or NASA will become will become involved in this type of costly project in the foreseeable future.

Since neither NASA or the Air Force is engaged in day-to-day UFO research, neither one reviews UFO-related articles intended for publication, evaluates UFO-type spacecraft drawings, or employment in the field of aerial phenomena investigation.

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**REF : European FT Initiative...1st Interim Report**  
**June 1st 1999.**

Project FT (Flying Triangles) has compared the FT sightings from the European Mainland and Scandinavia with FT sightings over the United Kingdom which occurred during the same 'work period' (Sunset to following Sunrise) between 1993 and 1997.

Of the 93 FT reports received from the European / Scandinavian area we have 62 instances where a FT report was followed (or was preceded by) a similar report from the UK within three hours. In 35 cases both FT reports were within 60 minutes of each other. (Of those, six were within 15 mins. and a further ten within 30 mins.)

Having noted the distance between each sighting location and the reported time of the sighting, we calculated the speed of the FT assuming that the same craft was involved in both reports. We accept that one cannot be certain that the same craft was involved in each sighting, though our database indicates that there are few FT's operating at any one time.

1. It was noticeable that whereas the FT when over the UK normally travels between 20 - 60 mph (32 - 96 kph) between the UK Nuclear Power Stations, its speeds are generally much higher when coming in from (or going to) Mainland Europe or Scandinavia. Ranging between 32 mph and 1252 mph. The average speed was 428 mph. It was noted that the calculated speeds are not random, but tend to 'cluster' around set speeds.

Example : In ten cases, the speeds were calculated at 123 mph +/- 17 mph. (+- 14%)

2. There were four 'pairings' where the calculated speed based upon apparent distance covered, would seem to indicate that two separate FTs were operating at the same time. Although it is possible that the FT 'jumped' some 450 miles (724 km) in five minutes and then 'jumped' back again to its original location, it is unlikely. We therefore discarded these four cases where the FT would have had to have travelled in excess of 1,500 mph.

1. Of the remaining 58 cases, the FT was in UK airspace before travelling to Mainland Europe on 23 occasions. (40%) and in UK airspace after being seen over Mainland Europe on 35 occasions. (60%)

2. In 26 instances the FT visited a UK NPS (45%)

3. Of the 26 instances where the FT visited a UK NPS, it was at Bradwell NPS, Essex on fourteen occasions (54%) . On none occasions (35%) it was at Sizewell NPS, Suffolk and on three occasions (11%) it was at Dungeness NPS, Kent.

4. Of the fourteen Bradwell cases, three cases (21%) are noted when the FT visited Bradwell NPS before heading to the Continent. On the remaining eleven cases (79%) the Bradwell NPS was visited after being reported over Mainland Europe.

5. Of the none Sizewell NPS cases, only one case (11%) was noted when the FT visited Sizewell before heading to the Continent. Of the remaining eight cases (89%) the Sizewell NPS was visited after Mainland Europe.

6. Of the Dungeness NPS cases, the FT visited the NPS before heading to Mainland Europe on all three occasions.

7. Of the 26 instances where the FT visited a UK NPS, seven cases (27%) were noted when the FT visited a UK NPS before heading to the Continent. Of the remaining nineteen cases (73%) the UK NPS was visited after visiting Mainland Europe.

The last statistic (7) is significantly at variance to the overall distribution (1).

A graph of distance / speed appears to show some correlation though more data is required before any definitive conclusions can be reached.

Ever since the Millennium my weekly copies have featured such things as The Scoble Experiment, and a full page article (Jan 8th) has the Society for Psychical Research spokesman Montague Keene and others strongly refuting allegations of possible fraud after he and colleagues and scientists etc had sat in on the sessions in Norfolk, pointing out sceptics etc put forward "impossible" permutations of super clever magical etc tricks which bear little resemblance to the actuality. Nothing surprising to UFOlogists there !

The book of The Scoble Experiment contains some

fascinating photos etc.. not only "spiritual" but what appears to be other worlds and possibly inhabitants thereof.. photos developed from sealed brand new films untouched by human hand in all vases, some left casually on a table when cameras were deemed superfluous in time. Those of us who have had personal experiences of "ghosts" etc, like those UFO's, don't need convincing !

"PN" for February 19th had good review of new book, the "Martian Genesis" by Herbie Brennan... a very prolific author indeed... and his "extraterrestrial origins of the human race" (publishers Piatkus) looks fascinating. As does his "The Atlantic Enigma" from the same publishing house. All reviewed books stocked by "PN".

There you go, then, hope some of all this has tickled your interest... many years ago I too was one of those who didn't think the "paranormal" had any connection with our sacrosanct UFO's. Personal experiences and a hopefully open mind has changed that considerably and contributed to my eventual development of my "inner consciousness". On that note I leave you until next time !

**U.F.O Boom Doesn't Worry Officials..**

This was a rather interesting article to kick off my year 2000 press cutting collection. The opening couple of paragraphs put the situation into perspective rather well I thought :

'just before the start of the year 2000, there were dozens of sightings. Strange shining objects were observed scooting through the sky by hundreds of people, from former airport workers to college deans....

"Warning Wuhan ! Warning Dalian ! Warning Xian ! Jiangsu ! Beijing ! Shanghai !" exulted the Jaingsu U.F.O Research Society's Web site. "Frequent U.F.O visits have enveloped all of China."

"The study of U.F.O's is fundamentally different from other things like Falun Gong and qigong, which have come under criticism lately," said Jin Fan, an engineer who leads the Dalian U.F.O Research Society in Northeast China. "This is purely a scientific field, whereas Falun Gong deals with cults and superstition".

"Applauding the Chinese government's "enlightened and practical attitude," Mr. Sun said : "In the U.S., scholars investigating this are under pressure and have been derided. But in China the academic discussion is quite free, so in this area American academics are quite jealous of us".

The cluster of dozens of sightings in the last four months have given China's enthusiasts new grist for discussions. most episodes involved glowing orange-yellow objects that were reported to have lingered in the late-afternoon or night sky for more than 15 minutes before disappearing in an instant.

Mr Sun and others credit China's two decades of liberalisation and market reforms for allowing U.F.O fever to flourish. "As China has opened to the outside world in the last 20 years, people's thinking has also opened," he said.

But Chinese U.F.O society officials say they prefer to maintain a sober exterior, often playing down controversial topics, which they prefer to discuss in private...

**Research Institute On Anomalous Phenomena**  
**Kharkov, Ukraine.**

My name is Alexander Beletsky. I am Vice-Director of Research Institute on Anomalous Phenomena (RIAP) - an independent scientific research body, established in Kharkov (Ukraine) a few years ago. We aim at scientific studies in the fields of the UFO problem and the SETI (Search for Extraterrestrial Intelligence) question. The Institute makes its investigations in close collaboration with the CIS Academy of Cosmonautics and Russian Academy of Sciences. Please find here attached (as appendix 1) a RIAP Information Leaflet, describing the Institute's research programs in some detail.

To inform the international UFOlogical community about the results of investigations that are conducted by RIAP specialists and other scientists in the territory of the former Soviet Union, we started, in 1994, a special periodical : newsletter RIAP Bulletin RB). It is the ONLY serious anomalistic periodical on the Commonwealth of Independent States published IN ENGLISH. There appear in RB research articles, short communications, book reviews, letters to the Editor, etc.

RB Vol. 1, No's 1-4 - Vol.4, Nos 1-4 have been printed and sent to subscribers. They contain, in particular, the papers "Post-Soviet UFOLOGY; a view from Inside" and "Alternative Science?", by V.V. Rubtsov; "UFOs as objects of Study by Terrestrial Physics", by V.A. Buerakov; "Search for Alien Artefacts on the Moon; A Justification", by A.V. Arkhipv; "UFOs : a Possible Mechanism of Formation, Behaviour and Environmental Impact", by V.I. Mazhuga; "The Petrozavodsk Phenomenon", by L.M. Gindilis and Y.K. Kolpakov; "The Black Ball: a Supposed Extraterrestrial Artefact", by V.N. Fomenko; "A Second UFO Landing on the River Mzha", by a group of RIAP scientists, and others. We have also published the first really comprehensive survey of anomalous features of the famous Tunguska explosion ("The Tunguska Meteorite: A Dead-Lock or the Start of a New Stage of Inquiry?"), written by the leading Russian specialist in this problem - Nikolay V.Vasilyev, Member of Academy.

RIAP Bulletin is published four times per year. Subscription rates : a life-long subscription - \$100 ; 12 issues (three years) - \$50; 8 issues (two years) - \$35; 4 issues (one year - \$20. Airmail postage

### (Appendix 1)

The principle trends of researchers of the institute in the UFO field are as follows : creation of an efficient system of reconstruction of a real anomalous event on the basis of witnesses testimonies ; formation of a unified CIS UFO data base (in collaboration with the Expert Group on Anomalous Atmospheric Phenomena of the Russian Academy of Sciences) and a computer expert system to identify genuine UFOs (GUFOs); development of physical models of GUFOs; monitoring of a place of recurrent UFO landings on the river Mzha, near Kharkov; studies in the hidden history of Soviet UFOlogy.

In the SETI field, there was realised, under the guidance of Alexey V. Arkhipov, phase 1 of the program "Search for Alien Artefacts on the Moon" (SAAM) and its results were presented on the pages of RIAP Bulletin. Besides, we have been examining some enigmatic finds that can be considered candidate extraterrestrial artefacts (ancient, or not so ancient). These are the so-called "Kassimov Ball" - a small (diameter some 4.5 cm) black ball of unknown origin, found in Central Russia in 1983 on the depth 7 meters, in a layer of pure red clay, - and the remains of a strange object that obviously originated from space and fell down near Kharkov in 1994 (judging from its chemical composition, it is neither a meteorite, nor terrestrial space junk).

The institute pays considerable attention to the problem of the Tunguska explosion in 1908. We are studying statistical parameters of the forest fall area, as well as the biogeochemical elemental and isotopic anomalies and population-genetic effects, revealed in the area of the catastrophe. A state-of-the-art collection of research papers on the Tunguska problem is now under preparation.

The Scientific Council and Advisory Board of the Institute include such Russian and Ukrainian specialists in the UFO problem and SETI field as Dr. E.A.Ermilov (specialist in radio detection of aerial anomalous phenomena), Dr. V.N.Fomenko (investigator of the famous Vashka find, as well as other supposed ET artefacts), Y.A. Fomin (doyen of UFO studies in Russia), DR. L.M. Gindilis (astronomer and SETI expert), Dr. Y.V.Platov

(Vice-Chairman of the Academic UFO study Group), Dr. V.K. Zhuravlev (investigator of the Tunguska explosion), and others. The Advisory Board comprehends also a group of well-known Western scientists, scholars and engineers - V.J. Ballester Olmos (Spain), Dr. T.E. Bullard (USA), Dr. R.F. Haines (USA), Dr. A. Meessen (Belgium), et al. Dr. Vladimr V. Rubtsov, Full Member of the CIS Academy of Cosmonautics and one of the pioneers of UFOlogical studies in the former USSR, is director of RIAP.

**ET, no need to call home... you'll fit in here..**

Alien Implants, mysterious metal objects from outer space and bizarre encounters of the fourth kind sound more like an episode from The X Files than an exhibition for public consumption.

But these arcane objects and events form the basis of Phenomena, a touring showcase on extraterrestrials and unidentified flying objects - the first of its kind to open in Freemantle.

It's also the world premiere and project director Brian Borshoff said its popularity demonstrated the growing fascination with UFOs and the idea of extraterrestrial contact.

"Interest in UFOs is ramping up for the Millennium," said Mr. Borshoff. "UFOs are no longer considered fringe subjects, their study has crossed over into mainstream science."

He said people are so fascinated by the subject that UFO sites have the highest hit rate on the Internet and five of the 10 most popular films in history were about either UFOs or extraterrestrials.

He said the concept of UFOs had become so entrenched around the world that an image of a flying saucer was instantly recognised - transcending language barriers.

"They have become a cultural icon, which is amazing for something we still don't know the truth about."

The exhibition at the Freemantle Passenger Terminal is separated into seven "pods" examining everything from the history of UFO sightings to the evidence of contact, details of alien abductions and even the sighting of crop circles which date back to 1678.

Researchers spent months scouring the world, gathering everything available on the subject from photographs to detailed witnesses accounts and

potential physical evidence from other worlds.

Exhibits include video footage of what are believed to be UFOs, plus details of abduction experiences and the display of "implants" surgically removed by an American doctor from people claiming to have been abducted by aliens.

Also on display is what is claimed to be the first physical evidence of another life form - a metal sphere found on a Mexican farm.

made from an "intriguing" combination of metals including titanium, vanadium and aluminium, it is said to be one of only two ever found. The other one is believed to be held by US authorities.

"We have got the best evidence available, presented it as accurately and neutrally as possible and we let people make their own informed decisions," said Mr. Borshoff.

"We are encouraging everyone from enthusiasts to debunkers - after all, science is all about questioning".

Your editor has been exceptionally kind to allow me to have my own page in the newsletter... Over the coming issues, I hope to bring you a variety of articles on a variety of subjects. I am going to start off in this issue with a short piece that concerns an encounter that I had with a ghostly visitor. When, out out of the corners of our eyes, we both saw a dog enter the living room. we both turned around thinking that it was our dog Tara. When we both turned around we did not see our dog, so I looked in the kitchen. his is where Tara actually was.

My father and I both saw this 'dog', and were both very puzzled for quite a time afterwards. This incident definitely happened as described, and we are all used to seeing dogs around as we have owned dogs most of our lives. In fact I have been used to dogs all my life.

Since the time of this incident I spent a lot of time trying to figure out exactly what this incident meant. The only conclusion that I have been able to reach at this time is that one of our old dogs (possibly 'Duke', a lifelong pet who had had to be put to sleep a couple of months before) had returned as a guide to mum as she was close to death. This is only my thought on the matter, but I find it a very plausible answer as my mother died only two weeks after this incident happened...
