

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**A Letter from a Member...  
Robert Fisher... Bristol...**

I am writing a report which I saw in the Wiltshire Gazette and Herald on the 24th February 2000. It could be connected to a local news programme (West Points) which said that a 33 foot hole has just appeared in Silbury Hill. The logical explanation was heavy rain that caused the subsidence in an old shaft dug there in 1776. However, subsidence does not work like that. It is not clean cut all the way down, square 8ft x 8ft hole 100ft deep. The new hole is 4 feet in diameter and it appeared on the 28th May. On Tuesday afternoon police cordoned it off. On Wednesday afternoon it was already capped with strong metal sheeting and closed to the public. There was not the slightest debris around the hole. The hole was clean cut in the turf and the earth and grass seemed to have evaporated ? Silbury Hill is solid and there are no chambers inside, so where has all the tons of soil and grass gone ? Driver Clive Stevens is seeking the truth believes the mysterious coloured lights he saw over Silbury Hill in the dead of night. He said the flashing lights formed the shape of a flattened oval rather like a flying saucer, and he is hoping other motorists might have spotted them and tell him what they were. Mr. Stevens 25 of Upper Isbury in Marlborough was driving home on the A4 past the Wagon and Horses pub in Beckhampton at 4 p.m. on Sunday when he saw the shimmering blue, green, white and red lights in the distance. As he drew nearer Silbury Hill, he could see the lights were on top of the mound itself. It looked like the helicopter landing pad on an oil rig with all its bright lights, said Mr. Stevens a consultant on water softening devices, who was returning home after dropping a friend in Chippenham. He said it was a clear night with a bright moon but he could not see people on top of the Hill just lights forming an oval, which he estimated was about two thirds the size of the hill top. On top of the hill was a whole pattern of lights in a traditional flying saucer shape. They were flashing white, red, green and blue. I could not tell if it was hovering or if it was stationary ontop of the hill. It really scared me because I was on my own there was no other traffic about and you hear these stories of alien abductions. Mr. Steven's a keen military historian said he doubted the lights could have come from a helicopter or aircraft. The landlord of the Wagon and Horses said his telephone went down at the weekend and BT said it was an external line fault. The National Trust said there were no gatherings on Silbury Hill that night. A crop circle has appeared at East Kennett, also Furze Hill near Lockeridge and another one in Bristol.

I cannot but think the one penned herewith DOES deserve exposure although I have a disturbing feeling that the apparent world-wide clamp down... Western World anyway.. on recent NASA-films samples of which I've seen along with the SUFOG group and other items ongoing... is even going to reach the local press or public ! Hopefully I'm wrong ! But can't help recalling that X-Files series item that had it christened... aptly !... 'Deny Everything' ! Read on...

**"What IS going on in the skies over**  
**Southampton Water ?"**

On Friday the 19th May the Southampton UFO Group (SUFOG) held another "skywatch" from the vantage point of the hill behind the Millhouse pub/restaurant in Grange Road, Netley Abbey, Southampton. Those present were Steve Gerrard, Steve Rider, Andy Phillips, Bill Smith and Bill's wife Jean making up the SUFOG contingent. Nothing drastic happened until around 10.30 p.m., (unlike the last skywatch) when a strong light was observed hovering over Southampton Water in the vicinity of Hythe. The groups camcorder equipment swung into action, filming an amazing six minute sequence of events that had very mysterious consequences, still ongoing.

The "light" moved around in various directions, sometimes staying absolutely still. The film shows a light aircraft of some kind, coming out from the Southampton Docks direction... or Southampton Airport ?.. and then circling the "light" a few times before flying back. The plane carried normal lights. The first light then began to move towards the docks.. still quite low in height... and then came to a stop over a group of trees... the plane by now had turn around and was coming back towards the "light" and passed directly over the light and carries on its way into the distance. The "light" appears to drop in height and disappeared behind the tree line on the waters-edge of Netley Abbey. Having

watched the film I thought the first light might have been a helicopter as it shone a strobe type light once or twice. However, UFO "history" has many reports of unmarked helicopters that everyone, but everyone, denies possessing !

Once I'd seen the film twice, I began to make enquiries of various authorities since the first light was "unidentified". Beginning with the Coastguard at Calshot, they soon gave me the answer that 'nothing was reported'.. not even an aircraft ! Onto Hythe Police Station... ditto ! They patched me through to Bitterne Police Station since that stands in for Netley Abbey ditto currently... I knew that anyway... they in turn put me through to Police Central Control who also had no reports of activity or aircraft and suggested, in any case, the police don't possess a helicopter, only a plane... which statement had repercussions concerning a previous incident observed by Netley residents ! However, from there I contacted Air Traffic Control... denial of anything they knew about. I then tried Air Sea Rescue at Lee on Solent... an affable sounding chap also said 'no reports' for that night but put me on to some kind of Special Air Service who apparently oversee incidents. Nothing to report but suggested it might have been a 'private' incident. I queried this and was told Southampton Water wasn't a "controlled area" and 'anyone could do anything over it'. The mind boggled at this.

Finally, and in some sort of desperation, I rang, via the telephone book, the MoD/RAF/USADA (!) at Hythe... I mean, how high can I go?... and a pleasant enough guy briefly discussed the incident... when I described it he said 'you are talking about a UFO, aren't you ?' I said 'yes, since it was so far "unidentified",' all I was trying to do was to get any answer ! Not surprisingly, in view of my recipients status and organisation, he said he couldn't answer that one anyway but put me onto another source which gave me the by then familiar rejoinder. By then I had come to a full stop ! Can you wonder ?

The intrepid skywatching group repeated their practice of going on, after the incident, to Netley Victoria Park where they had encounters of a different kind... even more so than the first occasion when they had left the park rather

hurriedly ! If you are wondering what “spooks, ghost” etc have to do with UFO’s.. my friends, many researchers and actual “experiencers” have come around to the conclusion... backed up by notable professionals.. that “it” is all ONE that comes under the “umbrella” of what we call the paranormal.. an interdimensional area of science that Quantum Physics have made the paradigm leap into in the last decade.

Since I am just one who has had these experiences... still ongoing currently from the last sixty odd years or so.. I can go along with all this. By the way, those “ghostly” Park experiences were further added to over the May Bank Holiday when I casually mentioned them to one of the park’s tea rooms staff who I’ve known for many years, and who is aware of my interests, I got back a whole series of ghostly goings on over some years that some had UFO type details too. The same kind of incidents that my SUFOG colleagues have been reporting ! Plus the stinging proof of a whack on the bent over posterior of one of the staff -when she was alone in the tea-rooms ! Fortunately she is a lady who takes it all in her stride ! There was also that lighted candle phenomenon in the chapel top windows reported several times.

And... I, along with my driver... have again seen that huge reddish orange light over the Hamble area while driving, as before, down Hamble Lane to Netley.. my third sighting and her first ! Stunning ! Around, also, about the post 11.00 p.m. time. I’m still not convinced that it’s an emission from a Fawley refinery chimney stack in spite of the video I’ve seen taken by our group on a separate occasion. No answers from the oil refinery spokeswoman I contacted who seems to have difficulty in tracking down someone who knows the details !

Why, too, has it suddenly appeared recently after I’ve been traversing the same route most Sundays and such for some ten years or more at the same time ? Why have the Southampton UFO Group been able to film unidentified objects not less than four times in the last two months over the area ? Oh, yes... thanks to the Netley gentleman who rang in following those first Southampton Daily Echo articles claiming to have the answer to my sighting... it was, he was certain, the ‘BBC Balloon’.. the one they use to publicise their programmes.. as he’s seen it going over Netley at 10.30 p.m. when out with his dog. I rang the BBC unit and they ‘never fly it at night’ and ‘mostly it stays in the garage’.

Which brings me, us, to another question ! What DID he see, then ?

So... the mysteries continue.. if only because those who are, one way or the other, responsible to us, yet hide those responsibilities.

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**A QUOTE FROM THE PAST...**

**General Nathan D. Twining** Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff (1957 - 1960). As lieutenant General in charge of the Air Force Air Material Command at Wright-Field, Ohio, he reported in 1947 on his investigation of UFO sightings to date :

**A :** The phenomena reported is something real and not visionary or fictitious.

**B :** There are objects probably approximating the shape of a disc, of such appreciable size as to appear to be as large as man-made aircraft.

**C :** There is a possibility that some of the incidents may be caused by natural phenomena, such as meteors.

**D :** The reported operating characteristics such as extreme rates of climb, manoeuvrability (particularly in roll), and action which must be considered evasive when sighted or contacted by friendly aircraft and radar, lend belief to the possibility that some of the objects are controlled either manually, automatically, or remotely.

**(Letter to the Commanding General of the U.S. Army Air Forces, September 23, 1947).**

**(From Brian James (BUFORA))**

Rendlesham forest 2000 breaking news of fresh incident the rendezvous with veteran Rendlesham researcher and author of "Skycrash" occurred around 22.30. 3 of us from the Norwich group now joining with the usual suspects from the Ipswich and Colchester UFO groups in their usual monthly prowl through the trees-ground zero (Halt) across to GZ (Larry Warren) and nothing seemed odd until we hit the section of forest directly adjacent to the Warren version of the story where a farm sprinkler beat out a steady swishing in the darkening forest. All of us felt it - like walking into into a black hole where the trees obscured all remaining light and the atmosphere felt un naturally heavy. Several of us felt a distinct tightness around the abdomen accompanied by a mild nausea. Brenda Butler informed us that in this exact same spot she and a colleague had recently experienced significant time loss. My own feeling was that she could not be more correct. There was something in this forest that possessed a timeless quality in something far beyond the poetic definition. Certainly it would explain a great deal - whoever's story one chose to believe about the events of December 1980, but also, the presence of some kind of temporal anomaly here might help us understand some of the event more bizarre encounters people had reported here in much more recent times, such as entities emerging from trees and, balls of intelligent light and even an encounter with the chappy-what's-his-

name goat-sucking-critter, whose name I could never pronounce. Due to commitments impending early on the Sunday morning we 3 from Norwich left shortly, before Midnight. It was a mistake. The following day I received a call from Brenda to inform us that things got serious about 12.40 and the following is an account in her own words of the events which followed on the night of June 24th/25th Saturday June 24th 2000 Between 3 p.m. and 4 a.m.

**SUNDAY 25TH JUNE 2000** 17 people attended the sky watch - but only 5 - Gena, Alan, Ann, Darren and Brenda - and Mason (the dog) remained present when objects were first seen. At 1.40 a.m. we were all sitting at forestry commission track 10 by the bar in front of the cars - the bar is across the gate way to stop cars going up the track - Darren had gone to the car to have a sleep so he missed the first ones 1.40 a.m. - Gena suddenly jumped up from her chair and shouted - what on earth is that - we all saw 3 stages of a orange orb, 1st - it was the size of a tennis ball, 2nd - the size of a large football, 3rd - it grew very large. It looked as though it was hidden one side behind a cloud - but it wasn't as it was well down under the clouds - it came up from the bottom of track 10 - and literally shot up the track as a small orb then when it changed to a big orb it stopped and very slowly went into the trees to the right - before this - there was a big white flash of light from behind and one in front of the orb and a little round light came away from it and went into the trees on the left hand side of the forest, then a bright beam of light came up the track - it was difficult to tell how far up the orb came towards us - as it came up so fast then suddenly stopped - it was as though it had been projected from something very fast.

-2-. We decided to go down the track and have a look - Ann woke Darren who was a little bit upset at having missed all of this. We all walked down the track including Mason. Halfway down the track Alan looked behind us, as we were trying to cover all sides, just in case. We saw some shape shifters coming behind us, glowing like little fairy lights. One minute they looked round, the next long. They were beautiful, they were on the track coming towards us. We stood what seemed like ages watching them, it was then 2 a.m. Gena did not see these. At 2.15 a.m. we saw in front of us up in the sky a triangle of lights, a perfect triangle - the sky

was very dark as earlier we had a lot of rain - we watched this for a while before moving off up the track that led to track 12. We were making for ground zero - but on going past the place were Carl Halts sighting was - Brenda saw a orange orb hanging over the trees in the exact spot of Halts sighting place (we had only been there earlier). Brenda and Gena wanted to go into the trees and look but the others wanted to go to ground zero - you could still see the orb up the path - this was at 2.30 a.m. The next thing that happened was really weird - Mason has stopped on several occasions along the path, one place was at Carl Halts sighting place - it was 2.40 a.m. - on the way to ground zero Mason suddenly stopped and would not go any further - then he suddenly shot backwards past all of us as though something had projected him - we all stopped but after a while carried on - we got to ground zero, it was beginning to rain but not too hard. We left after about 15 minutes to go back to the cars - on track 12 we cut through the woods to go past the deer pits but missed the turning - Gena, Alan and Ann were walking ahead - Brenda and Darren were a bit behind. When we all came out on track 10 again - in front of us Brenda saw 2 silver orbs about the size of a large football going in between the tree branches - they were beautiful Brenda told Darren but didn't know if he saw them - this was then 2.55 a.m. We got back to the car at 3.05 a.m. At 3.15 a.m. there was a beam of light coming down the track - it just faded out after about a minute - at 3.30 a.m. we saw red lights in the trees - a orange light and a white light on the tree branches - at 4 a.m. it was a lovely morning - we all left earlier in the evening - several of us went through a tunnel of trees off track 12 - this is where Brenda and an American woody lost 4 hours, 2 years ago -everyone found it to be very heavy going and a job to breath - it is quiet in there and very warm - there is something about that place that is not quite right - Mason also refused to go through there last year.

-3- Gena and Alan turned left towards Woodbridge when going home. Normally Brenda would have went that way but she turned right to go through the back way home - at 4.05 a.m. Brenda looked towards the forest and saw a ball of orange light hanging over the

trees - even though it was daylight it was quite distinctive. Brenda said to Mason as it started to move across the fields, what now - Brenda kept driving and the light just disappeared - about 2 miles up the road just before you get to the Wa Church sign - 4 deer jumped the bank and landed in front of Brenda's car - she did an emergency stop and nearly went into the bank. The deer just stood there really still - Brenda looked across the field and saw this orange ball beaming down lights and chasing 2 more deer. She does not remember any more only getting out of her car at home. It was 5.12 a.m. The 20 minutes journey had taken her one hour and 15 minutes (her neighbour can vouch for the time she got home). She thinks she woke him up as he looked out of his window - she went to bed as though in a trance and woke up at 10 a.m. very disorientated - her face and chest were burning up and her head itched so much - when she looked in the mirror her face was bright red so was her neck and chest. She had a mark over her left eye and a swelling above it - she was still very disorientated, this lasted all day and into Monday. Mason was also very quiet and did not want to go out and just wanted to sleep. Mason jumped around the car when the deer came over the bank and kept going from back to front - can't remember any more. Brenda showed her face, neck and chest to her son and daughter in law and asked them to take a photo - but they didn't have a film in the camera - Monday - my eyes are very red. Hope this all makes sense as I am writing this I am reliving what happened and my writing is getting quicker and quicker. When I got home a voice in my head kept repeating over and over again. We came to watch over the one's that are ours.. our children.

**NEWSPAPER REVIEWS**

**The Daily Telegraph** of unknown date has the music section heading of "Aliens sighted at the festival Hall".. UFO by the American composer Michael Daugherty is pure theatre, strange sounds, and percussionist Evelyn Glennie dressed up like a B movie alien representing the Roswell incident's strange shards, other weirdly costumed figures making more weird sounds from the boxes. While the MAIL Letters page had a big 'un from 'artistic' crop circle hoaxer Wil Russell from Andover who claimed to be one of last summers circle hoaxers paid by the Mail who doesn't seek to deceive the public (?) and claims 'transcendental experiences' in the making and allows extraterrestrial beings might make some formations. I can personally understand some of that... although it raises more questions than answers... he sums it up by concluding they make circles

'because we have to'.. Personally I can't say the Mail picture is "art" as I know it.. more Picasso than Canaletto !

Although an early book on Crop Formations I was treated to has brought me into line with some confirmatory theories... "Harbinger of World Change" by Aleck Bartholomew 1991.

**Psychic News** of July 15th dug up my name on a "synchronicity" article I did a couple of years ago and I hurriedly made the most of that and saw a half page on the recent SUFOG sightings and spooky stuff in PN on the 29th July... thanks ! They followed that up, August 5th, by another amazing huge re-print of an article on the Millennium and subsequent goings on that I sent them in February ! Still... don't knock it, eh ?

**The Sunday Telegraph** .. again !... of the 30th July has one of it's weekly articles, "Strange But True" by Fortean Times Editor Paul Sievekin, which I usually skip through since the magazine which is quite popular doesn't ever do much for UFOlogy unless it is tongue in the cheek.. if I'm wrong, apologies, Paul !... but the headlines and the up to date cartoons are always eye catching.. this one was ! "Invasions of balloons from outer space".. sub titles "UFO's". A July 18th BBC 2 Newsnight showed a wobbly object video'd on July 9th over Northwich, Cheshire.. is that the one we missed, Steve, and Davinia saw too late ? Whatever... Victorian as in Victoria, down under.. and On the UFO Trail makes a smart opener with Paul Norman relating an impressive satellite photo with windows and infra red heat, 100 miles up off the State of Washington... looking for that White House lawn at last ? November '99 and why didn't the West know about it.. or did they ? More sightings from the past highlight the usefulness of a revised edition of Richard Hall's UFO Evidence due out currently. Magazine Editors had a go at plagiarism.. a minefield if you don't know about it or your morals aren't ! Permission sought and usually granted where credit given and such. Puerto Rico in the news again with 'frequent UFO activity' ! reported, including 'strange beings', two 'human looking' and one not. Much going on around and near the Arecibo Radio Observatory... one report in 1992 had a huge UFO and three smaller triangles who all suddenly vanished. A 1971 soil sample report dated 1998 very detailed, even after being kept all those years some amazing results from the scientific angle. Loved Richard Haines comments on an FT sighting on the 31st March 1999 in Warwickshire.. fractal geometry, manipulation, materialisation, non-focal perceptual effects.. is this why those of us at Avebury didn't perceive the same object.. did our brains analyse it differently ? More on that in the Ovni Letter Page. Flying saucers over the Caribbean article leads one to think the occupants phenomenon has gone back to the Adamski days ! FT activity over Bradford in June of this year.. bright lights but no normal navigation lights.. see our own Avebury report ! try Omar Fowler at 94 The Circle, Sinfin, Derby, DE24 9H for all future events.

**Northern UFO News** is Jenny Randles particular well produced magazine and the Summer 2000 issue is just that... if late.. normal ! Jenny's Comment Editorial highlights the Steven Greer of CSETI forecast of mass release of THE TRUTH to the public and speculates if this is all another big hype that the Western media will ignore. Jenny also draws attention to the lack of books being published .. although I think this isn't strictly true... I have conflicting advice over my own manuscript which will have to undergo another transformation due to current events ! the epilogue is becoming book length ! A conspiracy, Jenny ? COURSE there is, thousands of us KNOW that ! Ask author Nick Redfern, still uncovering stuff ! **Awareness** magazine is the Journal of Contact International... this one for Spring 2000 so hope I am up to date... and notable items include a 2,000 ft crop formation arriving at Toot Baldon, Oxford, 20th July. Not sure how relevant "Toot" is but has very ancient sources. Porton Down exposed and mobile phone scares are maybe not UFO related but all knowledge ? Superb looking "flying saucer" Avro project projected to fly at 2,500 mph and almost invisible to radar etc never got off the ground in the 1950's. Rubbish reports.. since fighters were perusing UFO's in the 1960's and before going at impossible speeds ! Sighting reports in Awareness include an Azerbaijan film that made news in September 1999. A mobile glider enthusiast lost his controlling capabilities when a black sinister flying triangle appeared from a cloud and then silently moved back over Cambridgeshire

29th August 1999. Cumbrian triangle photographed and video'd by a Northwest Cumbrian UFO Research and Investigation Group on a skywatch 4th October 1999. Video claimed to be still awaiting evaluation and sinister phone call followed event. Other reports from this group suggest a flap in the area. Further afield an FT reported over Malta July 1999. Two USAF jets flew SLOWLY alongside the 'larger than two jumbo jets object until they vanished in the distance'. **SKYWATCH : SATURDAY 24th JUNE.****ADAM'S GRAVE, WILTSHIRE.**  
**UPN INVESTIGATIONS REPORT.**

We (Elaine Waite, John Hanson and Dawn Holloway) arrived at the above location which overlooks East Field at approximately 11.30 p.m. We had observed earlier in the day that a large area of this land had been planted with rape seed and although next to a formation, which had appeared a few weeks prior, remained untouched. It was here that we decided to make to camp for the night in a cut out on the main road into Alton Barnes.

First we observed a white car which initially we thought contained two occupants. Later we discovered that the car was empty (after John shined a very powerful torch into it). We noted the registration just in case it was needed later.

We had been observing the field from the fence

for approximately three quarters of an hour when we heard voices, which we thought were coming from the field below is. Scanning the area with our high powered torch, we failed to find out where the voices were coming from.

A short while later now freezing from the feet upwards, we retired to sit in the car and watch out of the window. During the next hour or so we noticed several planes at altitude fly pass, about a dozen or more satellites pass over head, the odd shooting star, but no sign of anything extraterrestrial !

At approx. 12 : 40 and by this time extremely tired and cold, we witnessed something that I have personally never seen before - a huge fireball plummeting to earth over East Field. We all witnessed this ball of light with a tail approximately a mile in length lighting up the sky with lime green, yellow and red. It literally took our breath away as we scrambled for the video camera but within 10 seconds, it may have been less, there was nothing to be seen. The fireball must have been no more than a quarter of a mile away from us and for a brief second we all ducked and gasped in awe at the sight we witnessed. A shooting star would be quite an anticlimax after seeing this, but we did see the odd one or two afterwards.

At approximately 1.30 a.m. we decided to call it a night. John wanted to make his journey to Birmingham and I had left a sleeping husband in the car at the Barge Inn, probably wondering where I had got to.

So ET did not show up for our date, but we feel he did send us a message of apology by sending us something worth sitting up and waiting for.

This morning (Sunday 25th June) my husband and I checked East Field from the hill road just in case something had appeared, but it was just as we found it yesterday morning.


Unperturbed, we will be back in Wiltshire in a few weeks time and spend another late night sitting and watching and hoping that our persistence will pay off !

Following this we took our turn making it up hill to the two big crop formations above the car park.. Oddly enough.. or maybe not.. we found the complete opposite feelings to Steve One and Steve Two with the first formation feeling different to the second although both were energy giving. Lorna laid out on one and got an immediate headache ! Davinia felt disorientated. Think Mary did too while Jean 'floated'. Me ? I dunno. Lots of energy about... certainly I bounded down the tramlines afterwards. 
**One last thought ?**

On our way to The Barge at Alton Barnes, we spotted 3 crop circle formations, but only managed to stop at one (photographed and video'd).

Arriving at The Barge at 12.15 a.m. - great timing by Steve Rider... First pub stop of the weekend. After devouring Ham, Chips and Egg, we met up with Elaine Waite of UPN and researcher John Hanson from Birmingham. Staggering back to the mini bus at 14.00 hrs, we headed off towards Silbury Hill. We parked up on the main road near the West Kennett Longbarrow and part of the group went to investigate the formation. Myself, Steve Rider and Jamie went over to Silbury Hill and sneaked past the two sleeping security guards and observed from a distance the 2 formations in the adjoining field. We read the notice on Silbury Hill concerning the collapse of a 50 ft shaft that had appeared ontop of the hill. (We later found out that someone had fallen down the shaft a few days earlier and had to be rescued by the fire brigade)... We again filed into the minibus and headed to our next stop, Avebury.

A fascinating, mystical place, where members of the group where to have their own personal experiences... From the Red Lion PH looking out towards the 1999 'Hoaxed' formation, you could still see the outline on the side of the hill. We all decided to do our own things, and Bill and I decided to go for a walk and see what we could find. Walking over the fields, we found ourselves opposite Silbury Hill and above it, with the formations in the fields adjoining Silbury to our right and the West


