**British Flying Saucer Bureau :
The End of an era.**

In 1952, the British branch of Albert K. Bender's INTERNATIONAL FLYING SAUCER BUREAU (IFSB) was formed by Denis Plunkett. When the American HQ of the IFSB closed down in 1953, its British branch became the British Flying Saucer Bureau. Membership was approx 1,500. However, as a non-profit, voluntary organization, BFSB was forced to reduce its scope and confine itself to a local bureau in the Bristol area of the UK. Then in 1953/54 joined up with the Flying Saucer Club to incorporate the BFSB newsletter within the FLYING SAUCER NEWS. Then the BFSB went on to publish the UFO NEWS BULLETIN.

seemingly attached - was another light, surrounded by a flame-coloured glow. She drew a diagram for FSC. The 'glow' moved steadily forward on an even course, at about the speed of a transport plane. It followed the main Southampton to Bournemouth road in the direction of Ringwood. The object was also seen at Bruton, Somerset some 3 hrs later.

Hengistbury Head, Hants. 23rd June. 5 people watched a large brilliant white cigar-shaped object, larger than any aircraft, which remained stationary for 3 minutes, around 9.15 p.m. - before shooting off at terrific speed. Also seen by people in St. Catherines Hill and Pokesdown.

Hindhead, Hants. 27th June. A bright light, the intensity of a bright star was seen to move fairly rapidly across the sky, on a straight course, at 1.40 a.m. It gave the impression of being at a great height and seemed to be slowing down and speeding up again. Also, it appeared to wander from its course and correct itself again. Seen for 30 - 45 secs A noise similar to a jet engine seemed to be coming from a point some distance behind the object.

The magazine is a gold mine of sightings from all over the UK and the rest of the world including Finland, Germany, Australia, Southern Rhodesia and Johannesburg. The BFSB Newsletter concerns itself with the BOAC Strato-Cruiser sighting and much more. But looking at the 1981 BFSB publication, that is a different kettle of fish. This edition is completely opposite the 1954 edition and I think showed how UFOlogy was steering away from the magazine containing UFO sightings to articles that shows the lack of UFO reports being reported to group and so 'lets fill the pages with something' syndrome. These articles were headed ... 'Investigation and Research'. In Favour of 'Nuts and Bolts'... 'The Preliminary Classification of UFO Sighting Reports.. Man's Conquest of Space... UFOs and Psychic Experiences Linked to Natural Disasters... etc.



The Summer/Autumn 1954 edition in the SUFOG collection is a gem, like all magazines/newsletters from this era. Here are some of the reports from the Hampshire area (before the county boundaries were changed)...
On the night of May 19-20 (1954), two independent witnesses claim to have seen a huge circular flying machine, surrounded by a brilliant flame-coloured light. The object was at least 50ft in dia, it hovered gently at first, and then made off at speed. The only sound was a slight swishing. Miss Heffer has described the object she saw as flame-coloured with a deep red mark in the centre, and following - and



**No More UFOs? Tracking Service Closes for
Lack of Use.**

The British Flying Saucer Bureau is closing after chronicling UFO activities for nearly 50 years - because of a sharp decline in the number of reported sightings.

The group, which once had 1,500 members world-wide, used to receive at least 30 reports a week of sightings of unidentified flying objects, but they had now virtually dried up, the Times newspaper reported on Monday. "I'm just as enthusiastic about flying saucers as I always was, but the problem is that we are in the middle of a long, long trough", Denis Plunkett, 70, who founded the bureau in 1953 with his late father Edgar, told the Times.

"There's only so many times you can pick over old bones. There just aren't enough new sightings," he said.

Malcolm Robinson - Book Review..

Rendlesham is now known in the United Kingdom as the 'British Roswell', a UFO case of immense proportions. A case full of facts, figures, people and mystery. Did a UFO really crash into some woods near an American Air Base during late December 1980, or is this case the result of cover story after cover story? There is no denying that 'something' happened on 3 consecutive December nights, that much is not in doubt, but where does the truth lie? There have been many articles written about the Rendlesham case and quite a few books too and I have to say that as a book reviewer and someone, who has been sent all the previous Rendlesham titles, this book (for me) wipes the floor with the rest of them! Why? Well simply because the author has painstakingly researched, travelled, pushed, pulled and prized interviews from all the various players of the Rendlesham case (and then some). People may not want to read anymore about the Rendlesham case simply because like Roswell, they've had enough of it. But like education, you never stop learning. O.K. why is this book so different from all the others, well lets take a step inside and see shall we.

Scholars and students of the Rendlesham case know the facts only too well, but for those who do not, briefly, it is claimed by many who were there, that on three consecutive nights during late December 1980, a strange and mysterious flying craft flew through the forest at Rendlesham near Ipswich in Suffolk, England and landed in a clearing in which American military men from the nearby Woodbridge Air Base were confronted by something straight out of the Twilight Zone. There are conflicting descriptions as to the exact shape seen, but the general consensus of opinion is that it was coned to diamond shaped with strange symbols on it's structure. A curtain of secrecy was then thrown over the event for a while but in an amazing twist of events (certainly for admittance on the part of 'any' military machine), a statement / Memo was released (in a round about way!) to the British Press [**News of the World**] which brought this amazing case to light. ☺

The author who has always been interested in the unexplained, heard about the case and decided to enquire further, she looked through all the previous

written reports and felt deep down that there was more to this story than met the eye and so set off on a crusade for the truth which brought her into a world of conflicting stories and rumours but also, brought forth some startling information which clearly showed that this was no small time UFO case, this really was the British Roswell. The main witnesses in this case were the Military, but not far behind were many civilian witnesses as well, many of whom have spoken to the author over the years. This book is absolutely littered by civilian case after case after case of people seeing strange objects in the sky near Rendlesham Forest over the years. Clearly then we are not talking about an isolated incident. There are sightings of structured 'craft', red balls of light, shafts of light, it's just simply incredible the type of things that civilians have seen throughout the years (and near the dates in question). The author eventually spoke to someone of whom other researchers never got the chance to speak to, ex P.C. Brian Creswell as it was believed that it was he who was the British policeman who was photographed examining the site just after the incident. Brian gave the author a hard time on the phone and said, *'I known what I saw, and I'm not going to discuss it'*. Now what does that mean!! The author clearly feels (and can show in the book) that a good number of the players from this story, more so the American Military people, were soon shipped off from the base to other climates. Was this so that no one could get to them and find out what they saw? The author clearly thinks so. Major Edward Drury told the author that a D Notice was soon slapped on this incident, (this is an instruction to the press requesting them not to publish anything as it involves National Security). Jerry Harris a Woodbridge resident decided to go into Rendlesham Forest after his own UFO sighting to see if he could see anything. He was confronted on a logging path by two individuals, a British policeman and an American policeman. Mr Harris had a public right to enter the forest but was told to in no uncertain terms to 'go away' and to enforce this point the American policeman cocked his rifle and pointed it at Mr Harris's

direction. This was British soil and a countryman was not allowed his God free right access to a well-walked area.

The author then goes into detail about all the 'Flash calls', which were going on that night. These are major telephone calls from various Military individuals which you rarely get unless there is a major scare something of the nature of the Russians launching their ICBM's, but on the nights in question, lots of these flash calls were going around. What was less major than a Russian problem !! The author also tracked down some British secretaries who were employed at the base, they told her that there was indeed a major incident that occurred and that a colonel Spring was very much involved and that there were lots of British police who visited the base and she learned that there was a lot of radiation activity and coming and going of Military and British personnel, more so than she had ever seen in her entire time at the base. Another interesting aspect to this already incredible case, came when the author learned that a Law enforcement officer called Mark Beaucham who went out into the forest to investigate these strange lights, and disappeared ! A patrol was sent out in search of him, and they too disappeared !! More personnel were sent out and they too disappeared !!

UFOlogists the world over, know only too well that there have been a number of UFO sightings over Military establishments and bases which contain Military hardware or nuclear weapons, the author after speaking with Military men under Colonel Malcolm Zickler's command, insisted that there 'were' Nuclear Warheads in the Bentwater's base (near to Woodbridge) at the time of the incident, indeed, the author also found out that through the Public Records Office in London a once classified Government document clearly showed that USAF Installations throughout the UK were harbouring nuclear weapons as far back as the 1950's ! Stretching the imagination here, if, as some people believe, we were indeed dealing with visiting aliens, I'm quite sure that they would be interested in seeing how we 'ape men' are progressing ! On the night of 27/28th December 1980 two RAF police dog handlers were instructed to investigate strange lights that were seen near RAF Watton (near Woodbridge). RAF Watton picked up on radar, a large moving

unknown air target. The two RAF officers were soon confronted by several figures, which they spotted in their searchlights. Their clothes were silvery and bulky and appeared to suck in the light from their flashlights. The dogs, who were with these two men, started to go crazy. The following day a high ranking British police officer questioned both men and advised them to forget what they had seen. Their note books were confiscated and the log book regarding the events of that night disappeared !! Even more strangely, soon after this incident 4 British scientists from the MoD research centre at Porton Down were driven into the forest where they changed into strange looking space type suits with tubes running into air compressors down their backs. The Watton event occurred on the same day as the Rendlesham event ! Soon after the Rendlesham case, many personnel at Bentwaters reported strange visitors turning up in unmarked aircraft, something that never happened before. Jim Penniston (one of the witnesses) was told that some of these people were from the CIA's Langley Research Laboratory in the States, what was a CIA research team doing on British soil? The CIA clearly had a big role to play in this case as the author's book aptly shows.

The author also brings to light the United States Air Force Intelligence working with a Government/Alien project known as PPD (Project Preserve Destiny). Former USAF sergeant Dan Sherman claims that this project is so secretive that it was classed 'above black' as was known in the loop as 'grey matter' or 'slant missions'. The author must be congratulated on uncovering so much more about this case, but she did admit that there were still a number of people who were very frightened to speak to her for fear of reprisals or visits from some type of Government agents. The author also looks at a previous author's belief (Peter Robbins) that what may have caused the Rendlesham case could have been due to some kind of bizarre weather experiment. In the 1950's William Reich experimented with a device known as a 'Cloud-Buster'. UFO's were regularly seen around his laboratory, the atmosphere was filled with a black gluey substance and researchers saw weird gremlin type creatures in and around the area. Could a device of this nature have brought forth what happened at Rendlesham ! Reich was convinced that using his orgone energy invention, he could create UFO's to appear and fade out. The author also looks at other potential 'normal'

explanations and experiments that were conducted in the Suffolk area over the years and states that maybe our earthly experiments at Orfordness and Bawdsey (near the Rendlesham area) could have penetrated some kind of other time or dimension !

There is no mistaking the author's sense of varied explanations to account for what was sighted in Rendlesham Forest. She mentions that her sources confirmed to her that the secret Stealth aircraft was deployed at RAF Bentwaters during the early 1980's. The F-19 made 30 secret visits to RAF Middlehall during the 1980's, could, as the author speculates, witnesses in the Rendlesham Forest case, have mistaken the Stealth aircraft for something more exotic? This reviewer thinks that this is a possibility in other cases but I don't think that this is the case here. Fellow UFO researcher Brenda Butler told the author that she received a phone call from a woman who claimed to be a wife of a member of the ARRS at RAF Woodbridge who told her that what was reported from the forest was 'not' a UFO but was to do with the capture of a Soviet spy plane and two of it's crew !! Apparently the American's had stolen the aircraft which was hidden at the Woodbridge base. Is this the cause of all the disinformation and mis-matched stories? Brenda Butler also uncovered stories from local fishermen who were instructed not to fish in the waters between Bawdsey and Orfordness during the week of 25th to 30th December 1980. 'Officials' told them that experiments were going to be taking place that week. The fishermen were paid for any losses incurred by not fishing. Brenda was also told by a local fisherman of a strange craft with lights that was seen going into the sea near Orfordness. The author also goes into other possibilities, which may account for the Rendlesham Forest incident, namely Electromagnetic weapons research and also experiments with holograms. The author has uncovered UFO reports from the Rendlesham area going as far back as 1947, so any one who thinks that the Rendlesham Forest incident is a one off, better think again !!!

In 1974 another UFO incident occurred at the Bentwater base which at that time stored nuclear weapons. An object was spotted by over 30 individuals and two F-2 fighter jets were scrambled to intercept it, needless to say the object evaded capture and the incident was covered up until the author pushed people for more info about it.

Some sceptics have suggested that the Rendlesham Forest case was the result of the spinning lights of the Orfordness Lighthouse. This reviewer won't even go down that road, for this is the most stupidest explanation that I've ever heard. I've been in the forest, I've seen the lighthouse and it's searchlight, and believe you me, what utter nonsense that explanation is. Anyone who believes that the incident was caused by this lighthouse better go and arrange to see their doctor immediately as you are clearly losing your mind !!

In closing this review, I found this book to be a new wealth of data, I thought that I would be re-reading 'old hat' some facts of course are 'old hat', but believe you me, there is a hell of a lot of new info here. Larry Warren (one of the main players in this case) has a whole chapter devoted to him, and it's not that favourable ! I'll close with the words of author Georgina Bruni when she says :

"There is no doubt that something very unusual took place in Rendlesham Forest during the last week of December 1980. We may never learn the full story concerning these extraordinary events but as a result of my research I am convinced that there is a cover-up of enormous proportions to keep this and similar incidents hidden under a veil of secrecy. We cannot be sure that there was an alien crew, but the fact that a craft of unknown origin landed in Rendlesham Forest should no longer be in dispute. It "happened" I have presented enough proof of this that even the most sceptical of sceptics cannot argue".

The above in my opinion, is definitely true. This book paints a very convincing picture and warrants your purchase to make up your own mind. You won't be disappointed !

MAGAZINE REVIEWS
BY ERNIE SEARS.

Beginning with the popular glossy, on sale in the better newsagents and by subscription, and now MONTHLY, we read UFO Magazine with some anticipation ! Like much of the media during the early part of May... we wuz robbed ! Apart from a small mention in Graham Birdsall's Editorial we got just two pages on that Disclosure Project in Washington DC.. See cuttings etc. Interesting in itself but out-weighted, fortunately, by the wealth of other interesting contents.. A highly likely earth based "drone" crash in January of this year, still hounded by secrecy, another similarly dogged by secrecy crash of "something" off the Isle of Lewis in 1996, and various witness reports of activities in those and adjacent areas. 

Higgle de piggy this time... the system shot to pieces by the variety of paranormal articles, news shots, etc ! Here goes :

THE DAILY TELEGRAPH of a March date unknown... had our favourite Government Dept, the MoD waxing nutty with its new name for the internal Defence Evaluation and Research Agency now renamed... wait for it !... QinetiQ.. Yes, spelt EXACTLY that way. Don't Know why in case you ask. Cost six months deliberation and £42,000 ! Says herein ; 'it's positive, expansive, bold, and assertive, tones, underpinned by a good solid technical ring', eh ?

THE MIRROR of April 30th carried more from the newish "Psychic Team" as detailed in the last SUFOG mag... this one about time and space travel illustrated by an early Star Trek picture.. THE MIRROR of an earlier date ran another "Psychic Team" item on that other continuing enigma.. Life after death, spooks, etc and those university of Arizona experiments and wondered, in print, 'is this proof'? One scientist.. Schwartz.. of

the University had begun his research in the eighties and believed that his results demonstrated that galaxies, atoms, and such, contain eternal, living, and evolving memories. Collective Unconsciousness has been "known" by psychics for AGES... but unprovable except by anecdote.

THE DAILY MIRROR has John Mitchell again, 26th April, expounding on crop circles, relating to the puzzlement sometimes declared by hoaxers as they carry out their nefarious tasks at night. Carried a special 3 page feature on UFO's and Crop Circles featuring Chris Martin and our very own Steve Rider at the Leeds Conference 2000 and James Ewbank talks to Chris with interesting results. Wish James hadn't included that "little green men" tag on the sub-title.. Still, what can you expect ? Chris Martin's pretty unique photos used to good effect. Chris came up with a very profound statement that increasing use of ever-moving on technology will mean more and more quality photographic and film evidence that 'we'll have to start making serious inroads to the political domain'. Ah, well, Chris... go to it, lad, I'm behind you for one !

NEWS OF THE WORLD.. Yeah, a somewhat different item in my daily dose of news... coincidence (?) that the paper sent me a months money off set of coupons so I tried the Sunday edition and what did I find in the magazine section? An article on reincarnation.. Who did I see cuddled up to USA country music singer Gareth Brooks ? My Somerset friend Jenny Smedley whose book on her past life with Gareth as he was in the medieval years came out in her book. Ripples... currently being updated.. 'taint any coincidence that all this came about 'cos I'm an obsessed country music fan and more so dancer and write for a monthly paper on my meanderings around the local club scene... and Jenny is a country music songwriter of

local club scene... and Jenny is a country music songwriter of note, which has put me in touch with Jenny's recommended publisher recently.. Which has pushed me into ~~burning~~ the ~~midnight~~ oil on my unfinished manuscript of some 18 years ! Reincarnation.. Ah, another path down the paranormal field!

THE DAILY EXPRESS also had a column entitled 'Believe it or not, it's still a mad world'.. Contents said 'The day the world stood still, Britain's oldest UFO Society closes down etc etc, followed by a list of what people still believe in ! Flat Earth, Loch Ness monster, Shakespeare's a fraud, Crop Circles not a hoax, 'too complex', say croppies, Elvis still alive, boost your alertness etc by drilling a hole in your skull ! And concludes a nation that believes in the fantastic is healthy and who knows, 'they may all be right'.

THE MIRROR of April 5th has a Mysteries item by John Mitchell on the Jon Cainer Psychic Team page that shows an Adamski type scout ship and a column on how ancient aliens were called demons, fairies, imps, mischievous spirits etc, quotes from Jung, Mitchell's own sightings of "UFO's" but not aliens, he says; and he also interviewed alleged contactees for his Flying Saucer Vision book in 1996 who he accepted had 'genuine experiences'. Mitchell bases his 'disbelief' of "aliens" however on those vast distances they must cover and the "theoretical" answers.

THE SUNDAY EXPRESS of May 5th began the start of a now you see it now you don't mystery when the two pager article dramatically enhanced by

photos of a giant UFO, aliens, DR. Steven Greer of CSETI, and Beverley Glick who wrote it; hit the proverbial fan with you know what !

THE SCOTTISH DAILY RECORD was thus beaten to the post with it's May 9th two pager... also dramatically enhanced by photos of (suspect) craft and (again !) genuine Billy Buchanan of Bonnybridge fame. How the Record got into my local UFO friendly shop is another story... unasked for, six copies... I bought ALL of 'em. A really believable article with sightings even I or Steve hadn't heard of. With "THEY'RE HERE" emblazoned across it, the article, along with that of the Sunday Express as above, drew attention (and how !) to the Disclosure Conference to be held in Washington DC on the 9th May, hosted by Dr. Steven Greer, and featuring impressive political, military, etc witnesses prepared to speak in public before invited media on the TRUTH about UFO's, their occupants, and their "energy" sources that were claimed to have been back engineered for FIFTY YEARS by covert organisations using black economy in the USA... some of it obtained from crashed or SHOT DOWN craft ! WoW ! I lost no time at all in alerting our leader Steve G... furnishing him with an internet address as the conference was being broadcast live and world-wide. With his usual incredible technology expertise, (back engineering ?) Steve was able to get the picture via his state of the art equipment.. The picture not good but the spoken words understandable... so SUFOG now have two 90 minute audio tapes, a fifty odd page printout of the entire day, and many miscellaneous Press releases sent out by Dr. Greer and Co... all aimed eventual disclosure to the US Congress.. No doubt Steve will have his own comments in this issue of SUFOG. Expletives deleted.

THE DAILY MAIL "Night and Day" mag had.. Coincidentally... an item on the Secret Rulers of the World Series... May 6th !... and having watched it for connections with UFO's, abductions, aliens, as it said. I felt sad for David Icke who I once admired and bought his books. Stuck with it through all his allegations that the aliens... mostly 12ft reptiles... are walking around here disguised as The Queen, various ministers, (well, I can believe Tony Blair being one !) etc ! I refuse to comment further.

THE MIRROR of May 11th carried a huge three page article.. "UFO SPECIAL EDIT'ON" which Steve G has twisted my arm to include ! 'Green UFO spooks mum', and 'Top astronomer (Patrick Moore) speaks out on London UFO sighting' and 'inspected some kind of mothership' that 'landed in Leicester Square', and so on ! By then I'd got suspicious ! So IT WAS ! An advertising campaign for a new washing machine capsule containing powder. You'll have seen it... how can you NOT?... by now. It appealed to our editors sense of humour although he chickened out of writing it himself ! I found it curious, though, looking at it's timing. WHO might REALLY been at the back of it all? See later !

THE SOUTHERN DAILY ECHO sprung a nice one for UFO's and our own SUFOG by publishing a letter I had forgotten about, almost, I'd written, and illustrated it.. See the up to date website... with a library photo of yours truly and SUFOG member Andy Phillips. We got a very good plug, phone numbers to contact, and my information on our sightings... that May Southampton Water one shown at our meeting was simply stunning, even more than the 2000 one. As a result of that item in the Echo, we had some interest from the public out there and a small influx of new or would-be members.

THE DAILY MAIL "Coffee Break" section sometimes comes up with paranormal answers to readers questions... May 25th had the Bermuda Triangle re-visited with a very factual and almost incredible list of vanishings in that legendary region vaguely thought to be off the Southern USA coast, Bermuda, and the Great Antilles. Aircraft vanishing out number ships, the last such in 1986 and the most recent crash 2000 with a Cessna pilot complaining of being spatially disorientated... 'I can't see anything' were his last words. Although the night was clear and the nearby airport well lit.

THE DAILY TELEGRAPH, DAILY STAR & DAILY EXPRESS all seemed set to make June 1st a real humdinger, out of the blue ! My UFO friendly newsagent Richard scanned all the stock and came up with a front page and massive inner ditto photos of that pink and multi lit THREE MILE WIDE UFO that we first saw in the Daily Mail last year. The video, six minutes long and shot over a Derbyshire village, has allegedly been sold for £20,000 to an American film company set on making a film next year on the whole enigma. NASA officials, in the person of Dr. Bruce Macabee have asked to examine the film which is claimed to be 'the same as taken by one of NASA's cameras' The Telegraph's contribution was small but useful. The Daily Star had the front and inner pages. The Daily Express did a two pager with photos of previous alleged UFO's and "experts" explanations... some of which are known to be inaccurate !... I shall be following that up on my e-mailer!

STRANGE DAYS was the title of a cutting sent to me by my friend Prof. Leo Sprinkle from Laramie USA. Leo was the first professional to take abductees under his wing. The article relates how a nine foot tall steel monolith "appeared" at a park in Seattle, Washington (shades of Stanley Kubrick's 2001.. A Space Odyssey) It vanished overnight and re-appeared on a small island five miles away.

THE DENVER POST (also courtesy of Leo Sprinkle) had an article by Maureen Dowd, called 'Drill, Grill and Chill'... a tongue in cheek with a sharp thrust at the state of the world... and it's getting worse !... seemingly for our own good but not so, my friends. Huge airliners will crush runways, drilling for fossil fuel in the Antarctic and never mind the wildlife. Dump nuclear waste wherever we want. We'll bake the earth... brown it, sauté it, simmer it, serve it etc. Fifteen miles per gallon behemoths on huge motorways. You get the point? OK?

DAILY TELEGRAPH of May 18th... just discovered !... says Silbury Hill to be investigated. The hole at the top now threatening stability of the mound... good excuse for a three dimensional seismic scan we are told.

UFO and Ghost watch..
24th February 2001..

The day with forecasts of a below freezing night... and so it was as I journeyed forth a few hundred yards to the Mill house pub in Grange Road, Netley Abbey, around 8.30 p.m. Never mind... well wrapped up in my wartime fleece lined flying jacket and roll neck sweater etc. I met up with our Editor and SUFOG leader Steve and shortly after Bill and Jean arrived. Walking up to our local sky watch point overlooking the village and Southampton Water we settled down, warmed by hot soup or coffee we'd stored in our flasks. The evening proceeded without too much excitement, plenty of aircraft criss-crossing the gaps between the clouds... one in particular moving very high up at terrific speed heading westward. We surmised something military going on.

Certain lights over Fawley caught our attention as the evening wore on.. One was eventually identified as a flame from one of the more invisible chimneys. Another was an orange "globe" that caused some excitement as it moved northwards over Fawley.. It was my turn to fail to see it ! Steve got it on video... I've yet to see that... while my friend Lorna from her top flat at Weston saw a similar orange globe performing the same manoeuvre... oddly, her sighting was at around 11.00 p.m. after we'd left the freezing cold hilltop and were making our way to the Royal Victoria Country Park just a few minutes drive away where the second phase soon began.

Very dark, not quite so cold, we parked just outside the park gates. I had to stop for a ticker pill but it worked very quickly and I didn't need another that night. Walking and talking along the beach side of the park we reached the remains of the old jetty on which Crimean and World war One and Two troops landed ashore for the short journey up to the chapel and main hospital... only the chapel still standing in useable condition. The others had been this way before and seen evidence of the haunting legends there, for themselves. Although the "atmosphere" wasn't as powerful as before, Steve felt quite "at home" again. A lighted room in the tower of the chapel rather seemed to clash with the surroundings. However we pressed on and arrived at the tower frontage. I stood quietly for a few minutes... after all this was my

first visit there although I have encountered "ghosts" in the past in a small quantity... and "tuned in" to the history of the place. Walking up to the front doors I stood with a hands on attitude and very soon found a warm tingling spreading all over my body. Quite nice.. And "different". After a few minutes I walked back to where the others stood on the edge of the gravelled area and after a few words said I'd do my little meditation bit which is a bit more than just that.. Difficult to explain if you don't do it ! I closed my eyes and IMMEDIATELY the area in front of me was crowded with "forms", so many that they'd never have fitted in OUR "reality" but of course I knew that having seen such before, elsewhere. They appeared to be "nurses" dressed in blue-grey uniforms and "soldiers" in some sort of red. All were "misty" so precise details were correspondingly vague.

This went on for what seemed like minutes... all of them intermingling with each other, walking about, silent.

Whether this vanished or did so as I opened my eyes and came back to a reasonable normality or not I don't know. But it was quite pleasant.... A caring feeling. Steve Gerrard knows this feeling from his past experiences there. Bill was talking to the others and I put in my experience which he immediately said he shared... 'crowds of people' as he had just been telling the others. Nothing further occurred... I felt this was because our "ghost hunter" MIB Steve Rider wasn't present on this occasion. We walked back to the car and went our various ways to a nice warm bed... it was then about midnight I think. I don't think it was "coincidence" that on Saturday morning the 31st March BBC Radio Solent broadcast a phone-in concerning the haunted Park ! Several people told their stories... while I only heard it second hand I liked the one about dogs that backed away from the chapel entrance and on no account would enter it ! I am currently following the broadcast up with presenter Peter White.. see next issue ? Easter weekend is planned to be a repeat of sky and ghost watch with London based investigator Elaine Waite and her husband who are staying with me for three days. SHOULD be fruitful as I believe the whole paranormal scene is breaking into the open... for whatever reason ! We all have theories on that !

PARANORMAL ACTIVITIES.**BY ERNIE SEARS.**

An idea for this article has been sculling around in what passes for my brain for a while. Recently a situation has come into being.... Partly suggested by Steve Rider's long discourse on "ghosts", hauntings, and what has been experienced by some SUFOG members at our local chapel in the Royal Victoria Country Park, Strangely.. Or is it ?.. Our Southern Daily Echo and Meridian TV have highlighted the place and it's history... but only Peter White of Radio Solent brought up the subject of hauntings there.

An increasing number of UFOlogists have become aware of the intrusions into the UFO enigma of other regions that are also enigmatic. These have included spiritualism, life after death, out of body events, and of course "ghosts". Both Steve Rider and myself have had personal experiences of such over some years... Steve reportedly goes looking for such while mine have occurred spasmodically and I have to allow them into my life gradually. This situation leads into all kinds of byways ! You can get lost ! Quite recently I experienced another of those "synchronicities" or "coincidences" which seemed to open another door to another vista... still having connections with those UFOs'. Trying to be brief a group member, Davinia, phoned me to make a point about those histories of that chapel in the park. All of them didn't, she complained, contain the legend of how the Royal Victoria Park Hospital had been built in the wrong country ! The story is... and as a Southampton resident for all her life she knew it well... blueprints got mixed up in Victorian days and India... then part of our British Empire... got the building we should have and ditto us !

I could hardly wait to tell her the story of how I worked as a decorator in 1947 on St George's Barracks in Gosport... a massive building, took us months to finish the work. I well recall the same legend was going around about that place too.. And told Davinia about it. I was, at the time, idly turning over the pages of our Echo.. Gemini's can do more than one thing at the same time ! Page seven and I yelled out 'I don't believe it'.. Twice, over the phone! I was gazing at a photo of St. George's

Barracks ! In fact the name was emblazoned over the entrance... which I'd painted in 1947 ! Coincidence? Later that same day I idly... again !... watched a fantasy film on TV. It wasn't until later I noticed it was called "Dragonslayer". St. George was reputed to go around slaying dragons ! A Few Words From Group Member Jean Smith.

Saturday 5th May, just after 21.35 hrs, Bill, Mary and myself left home to go and wait for Steve Gerrard and Steve Rider at the entrance to Royal Victoria Country Park. We only had a short while to wait before they arrived and then the 5 of us set off for a sky watch.

As it was a full moon I didn't think we would see much, but I was wrong ! We were stood at the jetty opposite the chapel, looking at the sky, deciding what were stars, what were aeroplane lights and what had caused the waves to come in so big (especially as there was no big boats going past us at the time ?). When, at 22.40 hrs Steve Gerrard pointed to a light in the sky over the Docks. Steve Rider got the video recorder going and while we were watching, an aeroplane that was heading near the light, turned and started to go in its direction, while we were all watching. The light just disappeared. He plane started to move away and as it did so, the light re-appeared again, so the plane turned and headed in its direction once again. It stayed around for a quite a while after the light eventually faded.

At 23.00 hrs we saw a bright shooting light (more than likely a comet breaking up just by the shear size - Ed) fly over the park, which the men said could of either of been a comet or shooting star ? This was really turning out to be a good evening. There was another big wave, but yet again we saw no reason as to what had made it.

We stayed on the jetty a while longer and then we headed in the direction of the chapel. We all stood at various locations and my attention, as always, whenever I go near the chapel was to the top of the chapel. As many years ago before it was renovated into a museum, I saw a light (quite faint) at the very top and I often if I will see it again or what had caused it last time. However, my attention was drawn away from there and focused on the small tree on my right as it was moving quite vigorously and I felt quite cold on that side, where as the smaller tree on my left (I was stood at the top of the pathway by the chapel at the time) hardly moved and I didn't feel cold on that side. So I was quiet relieved after a while when we all moved back to the jetty again. By now the cloud had started to come in and was going over the moon. For what ever reason, we all had the feeling that we needed to be away from there. We couldn't say why, but I felt that we had out-stayed our welcome on that night.

Was it my imagination or did we leave the park with

more haste, than we did when we were going up to the sky watch ?

Despite the un-easiness at the end, I am now eagerly awaiting the next sky watch. My thanks to the two Steve's for taking the time to organise it.

POPULAR MECHANICS - MAY 2001..

For the first time, a large circulation general interest magazine in the U.S. has unequivocally stated that UFOs are real. The May 2001 issue of "Popular Mechanics" contains the provocative lead story "When UFOs Land," which talks about the investigations by Peter Sturrock and others of physical evidence from UFO landing sites - evidence that has been suppressed and ignored by the media. Sturrock was on Dreamland last year to talk about his book "The UFO Enigma : A New Review of the Physical Evidence".

In 1997, Laurence Rockefeller, who has long been interested in UFOs and other scientific enigma, asked Peter Sturrock, the former director of the Centre for Space Science and Astrophysics at Stanford university, to convene a meeting of a dozen top scientists to discuss UFO evidence. Researchers from places such as Princeton, MIT, Stanford and the Centre for Space Research in France focused their attention on cases where physical traces were left behind. "While their findings were not conclusive, Rockefeller said, "I hope they will raise the level of the debate". "Ask most scientists what they think of the UFO enigma and you will almost certainly get a scoff and a brush-off like, "There's not one shred of evidence", says astronomer Bernard Haisch. "That answer is simply not true. The problem is that this evidence does not follow our expected scientific logic, and so scientists dismiss what is, in fact, a huge number of accounts. Many sighting reports, as absurd as they sometimes appear, are probably real. Most professional scientists never bother to look at the evidence. Instead,

the dogmatic dismissals by professional debunkers, which are often patently ridiculous, are simply taken at face value”.

Three of the cases are reviewed in the article. In one, a UFO exploded after hitting the water near a town in Brazil in 1957 and left behind metallic debris composed of an extremely high grade of magnesium. It is now suspected that the craft was a classified U.S. military plane that used magnesium as part of its fuel source. When the material was sent to the Air Force for analysis, it was “accidentally” destroyed. The other 2 cases have no conventional explanation. One, which took place in 1992, concerns a UFO sighting by a Florida policeman that made his cruiser stop dead. “The scientific panel was very impressed by cases in which electrical equipment was disrupted,” said Michael D. Swords of Western Michigan University.

In another case, which took place in Trans-En-Provence in France in 1981, a hovering UFO left circular marks behind on the ground. The French UFO organization GEPAN removed soil from the area and found it had been contaminated with traces of metal, while the surrounding vegetation was damaged.

In 1977, a UFO ejected 40 pounds of molten, red-orange metal onto the ground in Iowa. After the metal cooled, samples were collected by local astronomer Robert Allen, who sent them to Wright-Patterson Air Force Base in Ohio and to the Ames Laboratory at Iowa State University. Wright-Patterson would not publicize its findings, but stated “re-entering spacecraft debris does not impact the earth’s surface in a molten state.” Ames Laboratory director Robert S. Hansen said it was not a meteor impact. Former Lockheed scientist Bernard Haisch, who was on the Rockefeller panel, says, “We need to be sceptic of both the believers and the scoffers”. He has created a website <http://www.ufoskeptics.org> to encourage mainstream scientists to reconsider UFO evidence. “UFO sightings are not limited to farmers in backward rural areas,” he says. “There are astronomers and pilots and NASA engineers who have witnessed events for which there is no plausible conventional explanation.” <http://popularmechanics.com>

I'm really not sure who those men were but too many things have since happened for it all to be a joke. But I wonder what will happen next?


SUF0G ODDS 'N SOD'S

However, after an hour or so of jovial banter and freezing off our proverbial's, it was decided to make our way down to Victoria Park for whatever remained of the rather overcast night.

Stood on the shore with the imposing structure of the old chapel silently watching over us, we chatted in the calm of the cold night.

We walked up to the chapel and stood quietly in its presence to allow the atmosphere to release to us whatever presences might be there that night.

My experiences this night were different to any others I have had while stood here. The first sensation I had was the feeling of the air around me warming up, which in turn caused my hands to heat up which Elaine felt as we stood there. What happened shortly after is the most uncomfortable experience I have had here. While I stood calmly soaking up the atmosphere, I had the vision of a young man who was having a leg amputated without the use of any type of anaesthetic. This suggests to me that I was experiencing something from the early history of the hospital.

Not long after we decided to leave, but none of us were comfortable and I had a strong feeling of being watched as we left that night.

Sunday 15th

Having spent the morning at my youngest daughters christening I went home and changed, then drove down to pick up Steve G. We drove to Netley Abbey where we were due to meet Elaine and Ernie. After some wait, a text message to Elaine and a walk around the Abbey, I got a call on my mobile from Elaine saying she was in the car park. So we all finally met up, minus Ernie who had a prior engagement.

We walked around the ruins and then up into Westwood. The talk was very light-hearted as it is among good friends. However, I did manage to cause the only mishap of the day? As we left the hill in Westwood and walked back through Bluebell Wood I took us through a slightly small, but muddy area, which ended up in a certain person losing a shoe, I just hope she has forgiven me by now!

Back in the Abbey Elaine was sure she saw a fast moving object in the sky, but as per usual Steve and I were too slow and missed it.

We then drove back to Steve's for a chat and a look at some video footage. We also agreed to do another sky watch that night. Which would have been nice had unforeseen circumstances not arisen that made it impossible for me to attend the night's excursion.

All in all it was a great weekend, but a pity that it was so short as there was so much we all could have done and never got the chance to. However, I am sure this is not the last time that SUFOG and UPN Investigations will get together this year, so watch this space. You have been warned!

Where is this all leading?

Location : Royal Victoria Country Park, Netley Abbey.

As has now become our custom, we made our way to the location of the old jetty that is directly in front of the chapel on the sea front. On this night present were members Steve G and myself Steve R. along with Bill wife Jean with her sister Mary.

When we made our way to our vantage point we had no idea what the night had in store for us !

Our first sighting was of a bright orange light seen in approximately a South West direction. I got the video camera on it straight away. I was able to see a point that is visible on the video, that object was a plane, as it displayed the characteristic strobe lighting of a plane seen in the area.

Then at around 22:35 we became aware of a bright light over the area of Southampton docks that is visible from our vantage point. The light was stationary, or so we thought, so I started filming. The next fifteen minutes were quite amazing, as the light stayed over the docks, the police spotter plane came in to the area and past the area in which the light was visible, this is assuming that the light was not a great deal further away, just after the plane past by the light it, the light, dissolved away. Once the plane had past the light came back on. After a while the plane circled the area again, but this time the light did not disappear it only dimmed. Finally after approximately 15 minutes the light again dissolved away and did not return.

At 23:02 we observed a beautiful, very large and bright shooting star that left us all in awe, it was quite a spectacle.

Eight minutes later we saw a bright light apparently coming in our direction from around a westerly direction and 30° up. We thought we were in for something good, but the light instantly dissolved away after no more than 2 - 3 seconds. Was this the same thing we had seen over the docks a few minutes before, just saying to us 'I know you're watching?' or was it something else ? Who knows ?

We decided to walk up to the chapel, as it has become almost routine now to do a skywatch here and walk up to the chapel to see what we can experience in this atmospheric place.

Although I did not see anything this night, I did

have the feeling that someone may have been trying to talk through me, something that is often the case for a medium in a trance and for myself. Shortly after this I suddenly felt an intense wave of emotion sweep over me and I had to walk away, as tears began to well up in my eyes.

So we all walked back down to the sea front. Whilst here I could not settle and constantly had the feeling someone was behind me. This was coupled with some sounds that I was uncomfortable with. This feeling of being uncomfortable may be significant as we all left about 00:15 with a distinct feeling that the whole atmosphere in the area had changed. It is also worth noting that at some point earlier in the evening I had seen a bright flash of light that no one else had seen. This was similar to those Steve G. and I had experienced on our first excursion here.

The strange events that permeate this area just continue whenever the group comes down here for the evening. It is also noteworthy that not always the same people are always in attendance, something that can cause irritation when something fascinating is seen or experienced.

We will continue to use this area and will keep giving updates as long as we do so. I personally feel that the best is yet to come.
