**A SUFOG Perspective.**

It began with the delivery of the hire car at 10.40 that morning. I walked up the steps to be confronted with a gleaming new Vauxhall, Astra. At that moment I knew the weekend was going to be a success.

I picked up Steve G. just after 11am and we were on our way. Everything was going just fine and the journey was excellent. Then enter the M1, and everything began to slow. The next 80-90 miles was a mixture of fast and slow pacing that only seemed to be caused by people's reactions to other things like accidents and roadwork signs.

Eventually we made it to our hotel. We decided to freshen up then head straight for the venue.

**Friday 21<sup>st</sup>**

The evening of day one was superb we were at the venue around 6.30 pm. Once inside it was time to catch up with old friends. Time for SUFOG's first shock. After talking to Graham W. Birdsall, Steve G. and myself were amazed when he consented to our having a table to promote the group. So we set up our table and got down to business.

Soon it was time to start the evening's proceedings. This evening was to see short 15 min presentations by the speakers, which would outline their talks over the next two days.

The one thing that was sobering to note was the observing of a 1 min silence to take place on the Saturday morning, to respect those who lost their lives in the US tragedy only week previous. I would also like to pay my respects to those US speakers who journeyed to Leeds; they are an inspiration to us all.

So with proceedings wrapped up that night we drove back to the hotel full of anticipation at what was to follow for the next two days.

**Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup>**

We were up early and, after a somewhat hot shower,

then it was off to breakfast. We lapped up the fry up and then went for a walk in the fresh air to decide what to do. We decided to leave early so we could check on our table.

Once at the venue we saw a familiar face, Nick Redfern. Nick was bringing in some of his books and magazines to sell, prior to his move to the US. It is probably no surprise to anyone to note that Steve G. and I spent sometime going through the books etc. and coming away with some superb bargains. I am sure all on these shores will miss Nick, and I hope he is happy and has every success in his new life.

It was time to take our seats. After a short introduction by Graham, it was time to observe our minute's silence. I am glad to say that all respected it. First up to the podium was Dr John Mack.

Dr Mack presented an overview of his research to date. He detailed how he became interested in the subject and the problems with those at Harvard.

He spoke of PEER his organisation and of where his research is going now, that is in to consciousness. He was then joined by another of his PEER colleagues who spoke for a short time on PEER they then had a short Q and A.

Time for lunch and time to sit on the SUFOG stall and time for me to catch up with some friends. I spoke with Chris Martin and also with Mark Hall of Disclosure Project UK.

It was now time to retake our seats for the afternoon's proceedings. First we were treated to some interesting footage brought over by two Korean visitors. Then a surprise, Martin Stubbs was brought out. He had been introduced the previous evening, but Graham decided to introduce him again for those who had not been there the previous evening.

Then it was on to our next presentation. Nick Pope and Brigitte Grant gave their talk from the seats as a kind of interview style theme. We were treated to the story of Brigitte's UFO sighting and history of strange events, which led up to her abduction and eventual meeting with Nick Pope. I have to take my hat off to Miss Grant, she came over as very confident, considering the nature of the case and this being her first time in front

of this type of audience. It was interesting that she remembers incidents as far back as 6 years old and experiences with other paranormal phenomena including ghosts. She was also regressed by Budd Hopkins and it was found that 70% of her experiences were recalled consciously and only 30% required regression. This is a very interesting case and I am sure we will be hearing more about it in the not to distant future. Whatever happens I am sure that it is a great subject for Nick Pope to write about in his next book.

Next up was Georgina Bruni with her update on the Rendlesham Forest case and the release of the new government documents on the case. This talk was interesting and gave a good insight in to the fact that the MOD has been keeping some file on this case secret. In fact it is possible that there are a lot more still to see the light of day.

There is not much I am going to say about Georgina's presentation, as I was not that impressed, I am being honest. It was interesting to see her lose her composure slightly when a certain Larry Warren entered the hall quietly. It was also interesting to watch his reactions while she was speaking, including shaking of the head etc.

I managed to catch up with Larry in the break and asked what he thought of the talk and he said, "I just had to sit there and shake my head." He went on to say about some of her revelations "These are things I've been saying for twenty years."

After the break it was time to settle back for one of the people I had come to see, Budd Hopkins. Without a doubt this was the high point of the Saturday. Budd gave a superb overview of the Brooklyn Bridge case, as detailed in his book 'WITNESSED'. From he went on to detail some new witnesses that have come to light since the book was published. It was also interesting to note the religious connection that Budd presented. However, the part of the talk that was most stunning was when Budd put across his idea as to why the EBE's are coming here and as to why they have such an interest in us. He said that he feels that they are interested in us because we have a soul, we have feelings, but the greys always seem so cold and unfeeling. The way Budd showed this was the thing that had a lump in everyone's throats. He drew a comparison to the New York disasters, where a pair of works had been seen to jump hand-in-hand from one of the twin towers rather than suffer the fate that awaited them. It is this sort of thing that the EBE's are jealous of us for,

because we have this soul that allows us to be so close to one another at times of crisis and pain.

Budd was visibly moved as he made this comparison. I am sure that most people were, I know that I was. It must have been so emotional for Budd to make that comparison, especially so as he and his wife had watched the events in New York from their home on the opposite bank of the Hudson River. Budd's presentation was excellent and moving and one I will not forget in a hurry.

Next there was a short Q and A session, which was interesting as Mack, and Budd had a little session of their own, between them. It was rounded off with a superb question from the audience, "If you had one question for the aliens, what would it be?" It was initially put to Dr Mack who was speechless, but then said he would ask, "Who do you report to?" The other speakers then added their own questions: Nick Pope: said he would be too exited and would ask many like "what is your home world like."

Brigitte Grant: "please keep coming back, I am learning something every day."

Georgina Bruni: Just echoed Pope's comments.

Budd Hopkins: "where do you come from"

Graham W. Birdsall: "What are tonight's lottery numbers?"

That was it for the Saturday. It was time for Steve G. and I to return to the hotel and eat. So after a burger we went to the bar for what were the most expensive drinks I have ever brought, £3.05 for a pint? I am speechless.

We chatted about the day's events and then went back to our room ready for our last day. Time just fly's when you are having fun, it really does.

### Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup>

Today was an early start, so after breakfast we checked out and were off to the venue, with one short stop to fill up the petrol tank.

Once there we sorted out our table etc. and got ready for our last day. Then just when you think you are prepared for everything, Steve G. grabbed Graham and asked him what was the situation for next year's conference, as we would like to volunteer our services to make a presentation at next year's conference.

Grahams reply was, "you guys will do anything to get into the gala dinner" with a smirk. He was not joking when he said yeah sure and on his way out he said "we will take that as read for next year then."

Steve and I just looked at each other stunned. We probably remained so for the rest of the day.

So to the first speaker, Mr Ted Roe from NARCAP. Ted presented an excellent, interesting and professional lecture on NARCAP and the concern for aircraft safety in relation to UAP's. There followed a short Q and A session with Ted, Graham Sheppard, David Cayton and David Hastings.

Lunch followed with a chance to catch up with Chris Martin and a photo session with Budd.

Next followed Graham W. Birdsall with a superb lecture on Religion and the Origins program. I have to say that I was suitably impressed with this talk to order a copy. It was interesting to note that the Pope and the Catholic church seems to be looking very seriously at the possibilities of ETI.

Next up was Russell Callaghan, who presented a great lecture containing some great footage and quite amazing piece of information regarding the NASA tether. It appears as though NASA has been developing the tether as a way of bringing down old satellites, or was that just any satellite?

Time for another break and Steve G. rushed off, as he had to give his footage to Graham and Russell.

I was back in my seat after the break and wondering just what was going to happen. Because Graham Ennis had not turned up (in fact Quest could not locate him) Graham had decided to give some of the little people a say.

First up was Chris Martin. He showed a piece of footage shot over London of a large boomerang shaped, orange object. The footage is intriguing and controversial, is it balloons or is it not. You be the judge as I hope he will show it at our Open Day on October 27<sup>th</sup>.

Next up our own Steve Gerrard. Showing a piece of footage shot from Portsdown hill last year. It is no exaggeration when I say the audience was taken aback when the object reversed then continued. Just like similar footage taken in daylight in Mexico, as Graham pointed out.

Next was a representative from LAPIS. He showed footage of the recent wave of objects over Fleetwood, as covered in UFO Magazine in July.

Marc Hall was up next to talk on the Disclosure Project UK. Marc is hoping to come down to the October Open Day, so come along and meet him.

Last up was Martin Stubbs. Martin could be making his last appearance in this country due to his brain tumour, and I take my hat off to this brave man, he is putting the subject before his personal health. Someone this brave deserves the respect of all of us, and I wish him the best for the future, whatever it may hold. Martins information about the NASA transmissions and what has gone on behind the scenes was very interesting, especially so as someone else who has been involved has also suffered from the same terrible disease as Martin.

Next a short break. Bummer, Steve and I had already cleared our table, never mind we had done what we wanted and that was to spread the SUFOG word.

Back to our seats for the final speaker of the weekend. Santiago Gassa from Mexico. This presentation was pure pleasure. Santiago put across his lecture with a visual display and a totally hypnotic voice that held everyone. The high lights were exclusive video of flying beings that have been captured by Mexicans trying to film UFO's. What is interesting is that they were also captured on video in Chile during a military exercise. Very strange and the hairs on the back of my neck were ready to rise I can tell you. But all too soon it was over, even if some 25 minutes late.

There was just enough time for a few quick pictures and to say our goodbyes, and then it was off home.

Most of the journey home was spent talking about the weekend and what had happened and about what we were going to do next year. We just hope Graham remembers what he said.

The weekend was superb and I do wonder if you can top that in anyway. The felling of togetherness was amazing and something that made it all that more enjoyable. Just think about it as I list some of the people who came and some of the countries and groups represented.

Non Speakers included: Larry Warren, Nick Redfern, Alan Alford, Chris Martin, David Cayton, Omar Fowler and Timothy Good who was signing books.

Groups represented Included SUFOG, LAPIS, Yorkshire UFO Info, South Wales and Liverpool.

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The countries Represented included UK, US, Korea, Australia, New Zealand, France and Scandinavia.

So do I have any other highlights? Well perhaps Graham mentioning Steve G. and Colleague from SYFOG on both Friday and Saturday. Maybe Steve G. being the only one to mention me by name. Perhaps the book signings by Dr Mack, Budd Hopkins or catching up with Larry Warren, who remembered me and Steve after a prompt or two.

Do I have any bad points? Maybe, but nothing worth mentioning anyway.

I would just like to say thanks to Steve for sorting it all out and for mentioning my involvement at the conference. Keep watch for SUFOG in 2002, because we won't be staying silent.

What I witnessed at the National Press Club in Washington DC in May, shocked me to a great extent. But what shocked me the most, was arriving back in the UK, to find virtually no television coverage of this historic event whatsoever.

So I started thinking.....

"What could I do to help alleviate this lack of coverage, and to make the UK press sit up and listen?"

The answer seemed to come to me out of the blue.....

Attempt to start the ball rolling in creating a

similar event here in the UK.

The Disclosure Project in the US, already had London highlighted as a venue here in the UK for December this year. So, in conjunction with the Disclosure Project office in the US and help from many UK UFO researchers, I started contacting prospective retired UK military personnel, and civilian police, amongst others who had reported being witnesses in an official capacity, to the UFO phenomena.

I was pleasantly surprised to find that after they had viewed the press conference video and hearing of the good work done in the US, a large proportion of these brave people agreed to either appearing at a future UK press conference, or to giving their testimony on a possible briefing video to be shown to members of the UK government.

Since about June this year, I have put much work into creating the groundwork for an event here in the UK. The Leeds UFO Conference was a major success, and many people approached me with offers of help, but I came to realize that something of this magnitude was too big to be handled in a voluntary capacity.

This will be a major disappointment to all of you, but regrettably I have had to put Disclosure Project (UK) on hold until further notice, because of unforeseen circumstances and personal reasons.

I assure you all that I haven't come to this decision lightly.

Anyone who has posted a cheque lately to me as a donation, will receive it back with a written apology.



**DAILY EXPRESS** for September 4th... yeah, a bit late but our nice kind Editor Steve dropped these in December 1st... naughty... this one crop circles from the letters page ; Graham Block asks how do human hoaxers manage to remove the corn trimmings in silence and where do they take them ? **CORNWALL U.F.O RESEARCH GROUP (C.U.F.O.R.G)** 'Skywatchers' magazine for Autumn 2001 issue 34 printed beautifully in black on white and worth the £2.00... especially for the lengthy article by Whitley Strieber which had me engrossed totally and caused me to write to Whitley confirming and supporting much that he writes. Coincidence (?) that he says the paperback "Communion Letters" was 'virtually un-reviewed' and 'sold very few copies'. Crop Circle Mystery - Nov 5, 2001Herald Sun

Circle work has taken on a whole new meaning in the tiny central Victorian town of Tandara. The Australian Skeptics Society believes there is little more to the mystery than a man, a piece of string and a flat board. "Why would aliens do this? There would have to be a better way to communicate," Dr Steven Roberts said.

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**The Gundiah Mackay abduction milieu Oct. 4, 2001**

A preliminary report by Bill Chalker and Diane Harrison AUFORN.

An extraordinary and controversial milieu has developed around events that reportedly began late on the evening of Thursday, October 4th, 2001, at a Gundiah property near Tiaro, culminating in the early hours of Friday, October 5th, 2001, and then played out in the glare of rapidly escalating media coverage.

Three people were directly involved in these alleged events. Keith Rylance (40), his wife Amy (22), and their business partner, Petra Heller (39) were on their property, which was being developed as "Whispering Winds" winery. Other potential activities were also being developed at the location. The following account comes from interviews conducted by us with them, along with primary source material such as TV interviews. Keith Rylance told us that he had gone to sleep in the caravan bedroom at about 9.30 pm. Petra retired to her bedroom in the caravan annex. Amy stayed on a couch watching TV in the caravan annex "lounge room". Each of these locations were in close proximity, separated by a window and wall respectively from the lounge room. Petra's room had a door leading to the lounge room, which was left

ajar. The door to the bedroom, where Keith was, apparently was open to the lounge room. Amy apparently fell asleep on the couch. A storm was in the area.

Around 11.15 pm, Petra was reportedly woken up and when she entered the adjacent lounge was confronted by an extraordinary sight, that allegedly quickly overwhelmed her. A rectangular beam of light was being projected through the open window of the caravan lounge room. This light beam appeared to be truncated at the end. Inside the beam Petra claims to have seen Amy in a sleep prone position, being carried out head first through the window.

Underneath her, also within the beam were the items that had been on the coffee table adjacent to the couch Amy had been on. Before apparently fainting in shock Petra saw that the beam was coming from a disc shaped UFO hovering just above the ground a short distance away, near a tree at the rear of the clear section, immediately behind the annex caravan house.

Petra reports she believes she was only in a faint for a very short period of time. Regaining consciousness, she began screaming. Keith reports that he was awoken by the commotion coming from Petra. As he came from the caravan bedroom and stepped down into the lounge room annex Keith claims he was confronted by the sight of a highly agitated Petra and the contents of the coffee table on the floor in front of the window.

He told us that he soon realized that the window screen was torn in both a vertical fashion and along the bottom of the window frame. Keith indicated that initially he could not get any sense out of Petra who was crying and very agitated, so he rushed outside trying to locate Amy. She was reportedly nowhere to be found. Keith states when he started to be less agitated himself he was eventually able to get from Petra an idea of what happened. Keith claims he initially refused to believe what Petra was telling him. He said he rushed outside again trying to find his wife. Eventually as the situation became clearer, Keith indicates he decided to call the police. Keith called the Tiaro police around 11.40 pm reporting that

his wife had been abducted and imploring that the police should come out.

The manning status at that time meant there were some delays in the police coming out, but about hour and a half after the initial call Senior Constable Robert Maragna from Tiaro and an officer from Maryborough arrived at the site. Initially police thought they might have been walking into a situation involving foul play, even perhaps a murder scene, but then the bizarre circumstances of the alleged events came into focus. The two people, Keith and Petra, at the Gundiah property were claiming that Amy Rylance had been abducted by a "spaceship"! The officers were struggling to keep an open mind. They were joined later by Sgt. John Bosnjak, the officer in charge of the Tiaro police. He had been asleep when the police called him to assist in the investigation.

The three officers continued their investigations at the site. They confirmed that Keith Rylance and Petra Heller appeared to be in an agitated state and that there was no sign of Amy Rylance. The torn screen was examined. A flowering bush, commonly known as "yesterday, today, tomorrow" was located immediately outside the left side of window, had indications of possibly being affected by heat or another mechanism along its right side. Oddly another flowering bush, a hibiscus, located immediately on the right hand side of the window area was not affected in the same way. The police took samples for possible later testing.

While the police were at the property, a phone call came through, which was taken by Keith Rylance. A woman was calling from Mackay indicating that she had taken a somewhat distressed and apparently dehydrated young woman from a BP petrol service station on the northern outskirts of central Queensland city of Mackay, some 790 kilometers to the north of the Gundiah - Tiaro area. The young woman turned out to be Amy Rylance, and the female caller was ringing to advise that Amy was apparently all right and was at the Mackay hospital, where she had been examined by a doctor. Keith handed the phone to Snr. Constable Maragna.

Given these extraordinary circumstances Mackay police were called in, making a total of three police stations involved in the investigation - Tiaro, on outskirts of central Queensland, Maryborough on the coast and Mackay, some 790 kilometers to the north of the Gundiah - Tiaro area.

A statement was notarized by the Mackay police with a Justice Act acknowledgement, that required

Amy to acknowledge that she had stated was true to the best of her knowledge and belief, and that if it is admitted as evidence, that she may be liable to prosecution if she had indicated anything in it that she knew was false.

This statement indicated that she last only recollected lying on the couch at the Gundiah property. She had no recollection of the events that Petra described, but claimed she then next remembered waking up lying on a bench in a strange rectangular room. Illumination came from the walls and the ceiling. She was alone. She indicated she called out and heard what seemed to be a male voice, asking her to be calm and that everything would be alright and that she would not be harmed. Soon an opening appeared in the wall and "a guy" about 6 feet tall walked into the room. The man appeared to be slender in build but in perfect proportion, covered head to foot in a full body suit. He had what seemed to be a black covering mask on his face, with a hole for his eyes, nose and mouth. He repeated his calming assurances. Amy felt she had been there a while.

The guy told her they were returning her to a place not far from where they took her from, because the lights were wrong at the property and it wasn't safe. She then indicates she found herself lying on the bed and falling asleep.

The next thing she recollects is that she woke up on the ground with trees around her. She felt disorientated, could smell the ocean, and indicated she was not sure how long she tumbled through bush land, but seemingly it was for a long time, but she felt she wasn't making much progress. She then came out onto a road that looked like a highway and saw a light from a petrol station. She walked into the station, where staff seeing her state, tried to offer some assistance. She accepted some water, as she felt somewhat dehydrated. Initially she was not able to answer identifying questions, and didn't know where she was. She was also asked if she had been drinking or was on drugs, to which she said no.

This project is not something of the future, but has been in existence since the mid 90's. Our investigation has revealed that most contractors are working on 3 year projects, and a vast majority of these have finished their work already. We know this all sounds pretty farfetched, but we have all the evidence that will be posting starting from today. For instance, the exoskeleton designs are on our site already. All this

information has come from an official government site and we have been approved to release this information by the project leader.

To quote Anna McGowan, who is the program manager for the Morphing Project at NASA's Langley Research Center.

She says "Imagine seeing a bullet shot through a sheet of material, only to have the material instantly "heal" behind the bullet! Remember, this is not science fiction. Self-healing materials actually exist, and LaRC scientists are working to unravel their secrets. What we did at NASA-Langley was basically dissect the material to answer the question, 'how does it do that?'" McGowan said. "By doing so, we can actually get down to computational modeling of these materials at the molecular level. Once we understand the material's behavior at that level, then we can create designer 'smart' materials,"

What is interesting about the above quote is the fact that she mentions that NASA-Langley are breaking down the materials to see how they work... why would NASA be taking apart something that they allegedly built to find out how it works? In other words, this leads us to believe that the materials being dissected are actually 'alien artifacts' taken from Roswell or some other similar UFO event. The 27th October dawned sunny and even warm.. A good start ! The splendid Peartree Church Hall on the outskirts of Southampton easily reached however one got there... our technical whiz Bill Smith kindly drove me there ... congrats on passing your test... that motorbike must have been draughty !

A trickle of helpers and even a few ticket holders and buyers were also present an hour before opening time. I set up my 'cuttings' stall which proved a draw while the books, buffet, raffle, and necessary equipment was organised and manned. Panic hiccup when Chris Martin wasn't there for his 10 am talk... phone calls revealed he was still sitting at his London home... later it transpired he had been given wrong times by someone who didn't even belong to the group and whose name will forever be unspoken ! Fortunately a colleague, Stuart Wisdom, of Chris stepped

in with his own video's of UFO's "on demand" photos and over London... and did a fine job at a very late notice and his first talk took ! Amy indicated he felt tired, sore, drained and lethargic. She asked a woman at the service station to take her to the hospital, as she didn't know of where else to go. The woman and her friend took Amy to the hospital. Later Amy spoke with two police officers and also spoke with her husband Keith from the hospital. She then went to Mackay police station where she gave the statement of events. Amy also indicated that this sort of thing had never happened to her before, but when she was in 5th year school she had seen a large UFO surrounded by smaller objects.

The police arranged to put Amy in a motel pending the arrival of her husband. He and Petra arrived during the day and indicated they spent considerable time with Amy discussing what happen. Extensive notes were apparently made and photographs were taken of a triangular arrangement of marks on her inner right thigh, marks on each heel and the growing out of her hair which she had dyed earlier in the week. Her hair had apparently started to show her former color, suggestive that some considerable time had passed for her, apparently indicative of rather more than a few hours. Body hair had allegedly also become somewhat more pronounced that would otherwise would be apparent for the short time involved.

Via an Newsagent's a copy of the Australian UFOlogist magazine was purchased, Keith, Petra and Amy started to learn more about UFOs. Keith Rylance contacted the Australian UFO Research Network office number mentioned in the magazine. Diane Harrison took the call Date: Fri, 5 Oct 2001 15:20 p.m. and for the next hour or so listened to the story that Keith and Amy told. Petra was apparently sleeping at the time.

Given the nature of the story, its complexity and the fact it apparently featured the alleged use of "solid light", Diane decide to bring Bill Chalker into the investigation, making contact with him during the evening of Friday, October 5th. Paradoxically Bill was scheduled to talk at a Brisbane UFO conference on October 13th, and his topics included "solid light" cases and the application of science to alien abduction cases. Bill put a call through to them at the motel, securing permission to record the conversation.

Once again Petra was not available to talk about her part in the alleged events. Keith Rylance went into considerable detail about the events, referring often to the notes they had apparently been compiling during the day. The details described covered the events Petra had witnessed, what Keith had experienced, and what Amy told them had happened to her during her experience.

Finally Bill spoke with Amy, focusing mainly on the events before and after the claimed onboard experiences, because Keith had already gone into considerable detail about the latter. Bill discussed with Amy her general responses and her physical state and her current state of thought on her experiences. Keith Rylance seemed to what to control how both media and investigators would get involved. His desire to contact the media promptly drew from both Diane and Bill the suggestion that he should think very carefully about the possible ramifications of doing so. Keith seemed to feel that it was important to get the story out, as it would come out anyway and this way he could control the way it did. He was also trying to restrict the way the investigators could or should look into their experience. He claimed they didn't need to proof the experience. While he didn't directly witness the experiences he believed both Amy and Petra.

Given the possible nature of the event, and that irrespective of the ultimate resolution of the affair, it seemed destined to be a big story, Diane and Bill decided to undertake an investigation. They had been given an indication from Keith Rylance that the three would wait for the investigators to come to Mackay. The claimants were in no apparent hurry to return to Gundiah. They gave permission for Bill and Diane to visit the property on the way. Bill arrived in the Brisbane area on Tuesday afternoon, October 9th.

Diane and Bill then traveled to Gundiah, arriving at the Whispering Winds winery property, just after 10 pm. Because of the lateness of the hour, we got the witnesses permission to stay there overnight and to conduct whatever investigation we needed to do. Keith had arranged for a neighbor to regularly check on the two pets left behind, namely a parrot and a kelpie dog. He indicated to us that it would be

okay to let the dog off for a run, but warned us it was very friendly but inclined to jump all over people. We let the dog off at some point and observed its behavior. At one point it did jump up on the window where the damaged screen was located. This gave some support to the possibility that at least some, if not all of the damage, could have been caused by the dog. Some of the damage on closer inspection seemed suggestive of possible dog damage. Our inspection of the plant damage also suggested possible prosaic causes, such as heat stress. A plant at the front of the house had similar damage and a healthy flowering bush of the same species that was at the window, was examined by us at Mount Basset lawn cemetery has similar damaged.

A gardener there we spoke to indicated that the species often had random or more extensive damage of a heat stress nature from hot sunlight. The prosaic possibilities for both the screen and the plant damage are only suggestive at this point and further investigation is required.

We undertook extensive investigations at the property and the area. Police were very helpful. Our investigation generated many issues and questions, which we feel need resolution, in order to assist interpretations of these events. Further extensive investigations were undertaken in Mackay, focusing in particular at the area where Amy Rylance returned.

These included attempts to reconstruct the circumstances of Amy's return, through onsite research. The BP petrol service station staff were spoken with and a surveillance video tape that may contain Amy's visit there was provided to us by the station owner. This part of our investigation also generated many issues and questions that need resolution if we are to approach any measure of certainty about the real nature of the events alleged.

Keith Rylance indicated to us he would be available to us when we got to Mackay, but it was made clear to us early on the first day of our investigations there that this wasn't probably going to be the case. When we contacted the motel where they had been the night before, their third motel in Mackay, we learned they had apparently already checked out that morning. We left messages on their phone but didn't hear from Keith until early on the afternoon of our second

day, as we were leaving Mackay. In his mobile call, Keith apologized for not being available, but was indicating they had relocated to an unspecified location after having fled the area.

The primary reason for this Keith indicated was that they claimed they had a kind of "men-in-black" experience. In this case Keith was reporting a pursuit of their vehicle by a high powered dark brown 4 wheel truck. The nature of this event apparently frightened Keith, Amy and Petra, prompting Keith to attempt to loose the vehicle and eventually leave the area. Before the completion of this preliminary report (14th October) we have heard from Keith again. We remain hopeful that they will get into more direct contact with us.

This affair is both extraordinary and controversial. Many have rushed to judgment, but given it's complex and evolving dynamics, caution and patience is necessary. We have many issues and questions we would like to try to resolve. Further contact with the Rylances and Petra Heller may help this process. The case is far from closed and requires an objective, open minded investigation. Only time will give us the possibility of resolution and certainty about this intriguing but controversial affair.



I recently received the latest copy of the Cornwall UFO Research Group's magazine 'Skywatchers' Issue 34 Autumn 2001. In with the magazine was a note from Dave Gillham informing me that the next issue (35) will be the last. This has come as something as a shock, and yet another brilliant British UFO magazine is no more. I have always enjoyed the magazine and it has always received a good review from our magazine review section. I will be in contact with Dave, to see if this also means the end to the group, as Dave only said that the magazine will no longer be issued. Keeping a group newsletter or magazine going has become harder and harder. So much so, that SUFOG has invested over £400
