hope it is not, as the small groups are the grass roots of UFOlogy, and without the grass roots, UFOlogy will not survive. UFOlogy must and will survive and it is small groups such as us that have to survive. I see 2003 being a difficult year for the group, but, with members help, I feel that we can also survive for another 10 years.

## TIME FOR A CHANGE CONTINUES

### The struggles of a small UFO group

It was in October of 1991 that a resident of Southampton was pondering the idea of setting up a local UFO group. Just a few weeks later that dream would be realised and the Southampton UFO Group was formed. However, what did not occur to that person at that time were the trials and tribulations he would go through and the blood, sweat and tears that he would put into that group just to keep it a float. That man was Steve Gerrard, the founder of the Southampton UFO Group.

I joined SUFOG approximately three years after it's formation. I had contacted Steve as research for my role as the head of the UFO section of a separate paranormal research group. This group alas had problems and several left, including myself, to form our own group. Although we were successful for a time personal problems caused the group to lose touch and so I became a full-time member of SUFOG and now, I am proud to say, I have become its secretary. I will also be honest and say that I am amazed at the way things have developed in and around the group in the last few years.

I have to sit back and wonder if all groups experience what we have done, or if it is just a few. To be honest I am not sure, but I have a feeling that most groups probably encounter problems like we have at some stage. So where can I start? Well I have written on this subject for the SUFOG newsletter before, but never quite like this.

At the beginning the group only met at peoples houses, but when I joined it was meeting at a small café in Netley and there was always a packed room with little seating left by the time the meeting began. Over the years, however, that has changed. The group

still meets in Netley, at the local CIU club on the third Thursday of each month, but now numbers vary between five and fifteen. A far cry from the days when it was hard to find a seat at the packed meetings!

So what has changed? Where have all the people gone?

I feel that it is a combination of different things that has caused the numbers to dwindle. People work different hours these days and often have to work overtime out of necessity. Although there is still much going on in the UFO community to keep people interested, there is still that air of 'weirdness' about it that puts off some people into attending a meeting. I also feel that some of those people simply can no longer be bothered to attend.

Membership of the group has still been surprisingly good, although not all of those members live in the area. What would be nice is to see all of those group members who live in the area to attend the meetings, or at least attend a once a year AGM. It would be a testament to people's commitment to the group to all get together once a year to discuss the most recent events in UFOlogy.

Getting everyone together is not an easy task?

It was decided by Steve Gerrard and others, that SUFOG would conduct a series of Sunday lectures, to attract members and give them the chance to hear some of the latest developments in the field by those researchers involved. However not all would go according to plan? The first few went very well. The lectures by Roy Lake, Matthew Williams and Malcolm Robinson were well attended. However, things would

not stay that way and the attendances began to fall until not one person turned up for a lecture by SUFOG's own Ernie Sears.

So it was decided to try something different and in October 1999, SUFOG held a one-day conference. Although it was reasonably well attended there was not enough to fill the auditorium, even though the group had brought in the respected researchers Graham Birdsell, Russel Callaghan, Lionel Beer and Malcolm Robinson. However, having said that, a good time was had by all.

In October 2000 SUFOG again went for a different approach, an open day. To speak on the day would be Steve Gerrard, Ernie Sears and Christopher Martin (Chris has been videoing spheres over London for some time and has authored a book titled 'Intruders in the Night'). This was a chance for people to meet the group and see what we get up to and listen to the personal account of Chris's experiences. I will not dwell on this except to say that eighteen people turned up on the day. The local radio chose to publicise it on the day, but even that did not work and it was a dismal turn out.

2001 saw the group's tenth anniversary, so we saw an opportunity to go for broke. We were busy with lectures, including one to BUFORA and a visit to the Quest International 20<sup>th</sup> UFO conference (second year running). We knew that we needed to something special to celebrate our 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. So we planned another one day conference/open day, but at a slightly cheaper venue. We also planned a superb line up of speakers in Chris Martin, Malcolm Robinson and to headline Mr. Timothy Good. By the time the day came around we were on a high. The publicity had gone well and we had just come back from the Leeds conference where

Steve had had a 10 minute slot to talk about the group and we had been invited back for 2002 to present a lecture.

It was a sunny day and we hoped everything was going to go well? Not quite? Due to a mix up Chris Martin was not going to arrive to do his talk, so what could we do? Steve Gerrard turned to me and said, "Do you want your five minutes of fame?" So I covered the first 30 mins showing SUFOG footage. I then passed over to our volunteer for 30 mins Stuart wisdom, who did an excellent job for his first time. The rest of the day went perfectly (not counting my poor job of displaying Tim Goods slides!). We had finally succeeded, but at what price? We now knew that we needed a big name in order for our open day's to be a success. However, the evening's celebrations went very well and on into the night, but it had been well worth it and we deserved it.

So, is all there is to the history of this small, but dedicated group? Oh No! Far from it, there is much more to tell...

Over the years SUFOG members have been involved in many TV productions, radio programs and so on, including the local newspapers. Are there any memorable ones? Absolutely!

From my point of view the memorable ones are like that we recently filmed for Southern Ways, BBC South. On this occasion the film crew spent some six or so hours filming with Steve, at his home, and with the group up at Cheesefoot Head, for a segment that lasted no more that 3-4 minutes. Then, they got the groups name wrong and showed a piece of footage of myself looking though my camcorder with the shutter closed, D'OH! I don't think we'll even mention

the filming of the Three Minutes segment a couple of years back? I would have to censor it too much!

I have also been on Channel 4's The Big Breakfast, but that was to do a brief segment on the Totton College UFOlogy Course, I will address the course at length shortly.

So what has been some of the lows for the group? Well, apart from the fall in support and the amount of work increasingly heaped on those few shoulders, the group has done OK and it appears to be picking up with the recent up surge in media interest. However, if there is one thing that has frustrated us over the years it is the times that we have been overlooked as research group? There have been many reports in our area that have never reached us, but have been published elsewhere. In essence we do not have a problem with this, if only those receiving those reports would pass on the details to us so that we could initiate our own investigation at the source. Can I give any examples without upsetting anyone? This is difficult! I will site the case I have recently written about at length in "Time for Change", that of Bedhampton.

Those of you who have read the first piece I wrote will note how we first became aware of what was going on. Since that time things in the Bedhampton case have escalated somewhat. Much more footage has been shot by the witness, Mr Woods, all of which has gone exclusively to Mexican researcher Santiago Yturria, well all except one piece that has allegedly been brought by the Sci-Fi channel and shows alleged alien creatures? SUFOG has made pains to get in touch with the witness and researcher involved, particularly since Graham Birdsall recently expressed the need to see serious UK research of the case, up to now though our attempts have failed. SUFOG is in a prime location to research this case, being as it is

only a short drive from where we are situated. In fact we have our own footage filmed from Portsdown Hill, where Mr Woods has filmed some of his footage. In fact I have some reservations as to exactly where Mr. Woods lives in relation to Bedhampton. It may be true that he lives closer to Portsmouth than to the town of Bedhampton, but this is just speculation.

I am sure you can see that with SUFOG so close to scene of these encounters to be left out quite frustrating for a UFO research group.

Now let me turn my attention to one thing that I have become rather passionate about in recent months, OCN UFOlogy at Totton College. What I am now going to present to you is the complete history of things that have happened and speculate as to what the future holds.

Back in around 1996 I attended a three-week course at Totton College on UFO's. I was impressed and offered the tutor, Craig Roberts, my assistance should he ever wish to take the course further. Approximately one year later, together with Ashley Bennette and Craig, I help to set up and run a ten-week course at Totton. Part of this course involved Steve Gerrard and Ernie Sears attending to speak to the students. This course went so well that Craig put forward the idea of designing a course to be accredited by the Open College Network, an independent body who accredit college courses. So in 1997, Craig and I sat on the accreditation board, along with Steve Gerrard, who was to moderate for the course. It was a success and we were given accreditation on three units for

five years. We decided we could go further and put forward another three units for accreditation the next year, these got through also. At this point the hardest thing was the research and writing of course handouts and I often sat up until the early hours at my word processor getting things prepared to my liking.

So everything was going fine, I was even enjoying teaching. The course was even offered on distance learning through Totton college's own distance learning facility. In fact things went so well that the students' wanted to set up their own research group to somewhere to use their new skills once they had finished the UFOlogy course. The group was called TRUTH, Totton Researchers in UFOlogy Theory and History. As a follow on from TRUTH, it was decided to set up a newsletter for the group, but no ordinary newsletter. It was to be a peer reviewed journal to allow TRUTH members and affiliated groups to have written pieces published.

Unfortunately, I feel that this is the time things began to change for me within TRUTH and the Totton college course.

Being a founder member of the course I had expected (this was probably the worst thing I could do) to be a part of the review board. Big Mistake! I went to college one night to find Craig with the first edition of EJUFOS (European Journal of UFO and Abduction Studies), he directed me to the inside of the front cover where all the people involved were listed. I found myself under Associated Reviewer, a very lowly position with no credit to the groups I belonged to. My reaction to this, which I have told very few, was one anger initially. I felt that I had been kicked in the stomach, as someone who had done so much I was rewarded with nothing except a position that, I am sure, was felt had to be given to me, there was no credit for anything I had done.

Yes I was angry and upset. In all the promotion I have done for the course at anytime, I have always given equal credit to the three of us that

originally set everything up. I just feel that I have to do this as I can take nothing away from the others involved and they deserve their credit.

You may ask why I am writing so vehement on this subject? Simple, all I ask is that I am given the credit and respect I deserve for my part in the course. I would like that respect to be given by the person who has taken over the sole running of the course with out so much as a phone call to me to ask if would like to help or update me on how things are going.

I really do not know what I could have done to deserve this treatment? The only thing that I have had to do was in 2000. Due to home and work commitments I was finding it hard to get to college and teach. This got to a point where I felt that I had to do something. So I contacted Craig, OCN and the course moderator, via email to explain that I felt I needed a break from teaching, as I was just unable to continue at that time. I also indicated that I hoped I could return at a future time when things settled down. It was a decision that I regretted and that I really had little control over. It saddened me that I would no longer be able to teach the course, but I wanted to keep up my work on the course in other ways. I also feel that it was at this time that I was completely omitted from anything to do with the course, TRUTH and EJUFOAS.

So, what happens now? TRUTH as a group is no longer functioning from what I am aware of. The course its self is due for review soon and EJUFOAS is still going, however it is minus its associate reviewer who was taken of the list without even being consulted?

So, what is going on in Totton? I really do not know, but I now leave this section with a heavy heart, having written on a subject that has meant so much to me. Only time will tell on how things will progress. Oh! Yes! Before you ask? SUFOG does have another connection with the Totton college course? Steve Gerrard is the course moderator.

As I write this I am aware that things within SUFOG are not as rosy as they could be. The attendance at meetings is set to fall again, perhaps we will be reduced to meeting in peoples front rooms again soon, and also our relationships with certain individuals has been jeopardised on a couple of occasions due to over-zealousness and lack of thought only for Steve G. to be caught in the firing line. Steve has enough to deal with away from the group without having to eat humble pie because someone has gone off half-cocked!

We need to ensure the survival of this small, but dedicated group of like-minded friends. There have been many groups who have come and gone during the life of SUFOG.

Let us try and ensure that the next ten years are as successful as the previous ten. Whatever happens I know one thing? There will always be two people in Southampton proud to sport the SUFOG name. Something not all group members can say they have.

One thought. If a group members contacts a large organisation to promote their photo of a UFO and does not promote the group what does that say for their respect for that group?

Southampton UFO Group has been involved in a lot of things and has not always been given the credit it deserves. However, not everything is bad. There is the possibility that we may be opening a division of SUFOG on the Isle of Wight in the near future, discussions on this are on

going. It is time to change that. Leeds 2002, could be the turning point?

### UFO REPORTS 7th - 10th September 2002.

The information supplied by Public Relations Officer Ernie Sears. Some of these reports followed a letter in the Southampton Evening Echo 13 September 2002.

**7<sup>th</sup> September 2002** : 9.40 p.m. : Lordshill, Southampton.

Two witnesses saw a hovering light caught the witnesses eye.. Disc shaped, carrying bright lights, two at the front and one at the rear, all white, but surrounded by a blue haze. The object 'Shot' off towards Eastleigh at a speed the witness said he that had NEVER ever seen an aircraft go at.

**7<sup>th</sup> September 2002** a Bishopstoke resident saw a very fast moving object, spherical and glowing a bright copper color heading towards Winchester at around 8.15 p.m. too fast to be a shooting star and witnessed by a second person as it 'swept upwards' away.

**7<sup>th</sup> September 2002** a Totton lady, around midnight, saw a bright 'Double disc' or like two slim cigar shapes carrying white lights and hovered for 30 minutes before it took off like a shot from a gun.

**8<sup>th</sup> September 2002** Romsey in Hampshire a lady opened her window at around 9.35 p.m. and observed an oval object carrying three white lights at the front and one at the rear. Going at the speed of a small aircraft, quite high and vanished towards Southampton.

**10<sup>th</sup> September 2002** at approx. 9.30 p.m. Bitterne Park, Southampton, witnesses 'enveloped' by a glowing white light, not bright and they couldn't move. They felt detached from each other. They regained normality of a disturbing kind. One witness still terrified days afterwards. They thought the whole incident lasted seconds, but they arrived home an hour late.

**10<sup>th</sup> September 2002** 10.30 p.m. over Southampton, a bright white light hanging in the sky and seen for 30 minutes. Lights on it changed red, green, white and very high. She went to bed and had the best nights sleep she had ever had and felt 'wonderful' the next day.

**Mt Adams USA) Sighting by group member  
Bill Coones. 1st September 2002.**

Hello: This is my first report of the UFO sighting for Bill and Ferne. We were staying at James Gillilands Sattva Sanctuary over the Labor Day weekend as we frequently do to skywatch near the base of Mt Adams in Trout Lake Washington USA. Steven Greers group (Disclosure Project) was there on their first night of skywatching during their week long stay in the area for their paid conference. I understand that he was not there at the time and was to arrive a few days later. Ferne and I were set up approximately 150 yards east of the Greer group for our skywatch along the driveway from the main road into the house. We saw several moving lights that evening and several lights (earth lights) on Mt Adams as we frequently see there on the southeast side. A few minutes after 11pm Sunday Sept 1 we heard several people in the Greer group to our left shouting in an excited fashion for several seconds. Wondering what the shouting was about we both searched the sky to see what they were looking at. Ferne saw it first and it was a triangle. The form was an uneven elongated triangle, one of the trailing lights was ahead of its counterpart. The brightness was dim but was readily discernable as moving together in formation. I hastily got out my camcorder and tried to video the object. It could see it in my camera. After a few seconds it made banking turn and headed back the same direction that it came from. In approximately three seconds after it had made the turn all three lights faded out together. Throughout the whole sighting the three lights stayed in formation and kept the same brilliance. This is approximately what it looked like.

It was headed from north to south and after the turn it headed back the way it came and rapidly went out. The weather was clear and there are no streetlights in the area. The milky way was readily visible. There was no moon. I think that everyone who was outside skywatching saw the object or formation, over 15 people. There was no object visible within the lights as they were not markers. There was no sound, or visible trails from it.

Its size was about half a hand at arms length. We were facing north when we saw it and it was directly overhead. There were no obstructions and we had an excellent view.

This is the best sighting I have had to date. I must note that we saw a triangle last September (2001) at the same location. I have not talked about this sighting to any of the other guests in the other group. I did tell James and Shaun what we saw. If anyone wants a detailed report, I am willing to fill out a form or do an interview. Ferne will also.



Not a lot this issue... distinct shortage of UFO items although Mel Gibson's alleged blockbuster film "SIGNS" got plenty of pre-publicity in the nations Press. More on that elsewhere.

**NEWS OF THE WORLD** for September 1st set the scene of that abortive pursuit by a police helicopter over Brighton with it's 'Cop chase UFO' headline. Estimated speed of object 'HIGH'... outran helicopter after a three minute chase. Wasn't until you read the last words that you discovered the incident happened a year ago! So... you might ask, how come the delay? Seems one police pilot has since retired and was able to break the story. Incident heavily featured... actual film... in the media and on TV before it died the death. Not before "experts" broadcast "solutions", taking in a 'Chinese lantern' in one case!

September 1st also saw a veritable flood of publicity in the News Of the World, followed by, on into the 9th of the month, by Weekend Mail, Daily Mirror, Daily Telegraph and probably many others that I never saw in the rush to repeat the alleged umpteen million dollar "SIGNS" profits!... Quotes from Mel Gibson in some of the foregoing included : 'God?... there'd better be something out there greater than me' or 'we're in trouble' and 'sure I believe in the paranormal, there's a lot of weird stuff happened to me' etc etc. Reviews mixed... from 'boring' to 'excitingly weird', and, from the Telegraph art critic,

'cheerless and filled with gloopy spirituality'. Lorna and I saw it and were kept waiting for excitement that never happened... also a dearth of crop circles and nasty aliens which isn't strictly true! Shot in the standard X-Files format of dimly seen and dimly lit scenes.

**DAILY EXPRESS** of September 7th posed a "why?" question with a full page advert fro a Matalan washable suit! Missed by some I showed it to was the connection with the word "unbelievable" against a rural background and tucked away in the top corner a UFO which one recognised from the Warminster era!

**DAILY TELEGRAPH** ran the selfsame advert on it's huge broadsheet as did, probably, other UK media... and all left the question... why now?... is it another bit of "educating" Joe Public?... or just plain commercialism? Odd that it is ONLY as I leafed through my copies NOW that the 7th of September heading of all that reminded me of those FOUR sightings over and around Southampton on that very same day... followed by a handful of others in the ensuing week... see elsewhere. Odd? "Coincidence?"

**DAILY MAIL** of the 16th September ran an almost full paper on that boringly controversial Moon landing... did they or didn't they? With it's big "Moonshine" heading and calling the accusations of a hoaxed landing 'laughable if so many people didn't believe it'. The article is heavily loaded with total denials by astronauts. As far as one affirms, he 'went to the moon and that's it'.

**DAILY TELEGRAPH** of the 18th September had a small item... others played it bigger... of the 100th "new World" being discovered. It is 100 light years from Earth and marks a milestone, it says, 'in the quest to find earth-like objects that could teem with alien life'. Announced at an Austrian conference on The Origin Of Life and discovered by an Australian New South Wales 3.9 million telescope.

**DAIL MAIL** dated 19th September does an almost full page on that perrenial and argumentative subject "The Great out-of- Body experience myth" as it labels it. Writer James Chapman... I had his book way back in the seventies on "Flying Saucers Over England"... says Swiss Scientists may have uncovered a "quirk of the brain" rather than "anything paranormal". Using electrodes they stimulated out of body experiences, repeatedly. Hmmm. I don't doubt this. My own 1933 OOBÉ arrived while having been quite ill... although the Swiss scientists who did this experiment on themselves didn't "go through doors" etc as I did... while the doors were shut!

**DAILY TELEGRAPH** ... 19th September, ran a bigger piece on the discovery of that 100th planet and water on three distant planets that are "gaseous" and huge and invisible but for their causing a "wobble to parent planets" that alerted Italian astronomers.

**SCOTTISH DAILY RECORD...** for September 19th... kindly put inside one of my daily papers by my friendly UFO orientated newsagent Richard... had "Magic Circle" headlining MORE claims by a "TEAM" of crop formation hoaxers who were paid 5000 by Channel Four TV to hoax a design incorporating the struggling TV par Richard and Judy which appeared in the media. The article claims Circle-makers of London as they call themselves, have done 'every other mystery appearance' but when one reads the small print there is no such statement, only that all the big circles have been done by them. Calling their covert work 'art with mass participation' the Richard and Judy faces took six hours, with 'just boards' to complete, and had the OK by the farmer... who also got paid. No doubt Busty Taylor and Lucy Pringle could destroy such grandiose claims!

**DAILY MAIL** for September 20th had a central double-page fully illustrated and with huge headlines on the Afterlife.. Or Pure Hokum. Knocking that "quirk of the brain" suggestions on the head... literally... the Mail printed several stories from people who had actually experienced OOBÉ's. Let their by-lines speak for themselves : 'I was taken to the edge of the universe and back again'... and : 'I was surrounded by all the members of my family who had passed away', and : 'being embraced by a presence I call the Being of Light'. And son on....

**DAILY EXPRESS** of 27th carried this theme on with a two pager on well-known medium Colin Fry who had an Express reporter Sally Eyden interviewing him with, she admits, initial part scepticism becoming stunned belief, hearing Colin relate very personal... even humorous... incidents concerning deceased relatives of Sally's. Colin appears on 6xth Sence (As spelt!) 1.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. weekdays on Living TV... the program under discussion as to whether it might offend the watershed as being "occult" or serious discussion etc. Since "fundamentalist Christians" and the likes have already expressed their belief that Colin works for Old Nick (excuse my laughter) even though the program draws big numbers and even though a Church Commission... pre war but kept secret until after the war!... examined the evidence of "spiritualism" and concluded it was totally in order.

**DAILY MAIL** and **DAILY STAR...** and probably other publications... did a wonderful job on October 4th... even as I write this!... with photos of the Kent UFO taken three months ago and it's remarkable... to some!... similarity to the famous McMinville, USA, sighting in 1950 and in Rouen, France, in 1964. Graham Birdsall's opinion was sought on this latest evidential shot and said 'if it was genuine, it would be historically important'. Time will tell... two faintly discernable lines leading to the "tower" atop the craft revealed by certain filter techniques may be image grain, natural quirks, or a hoax.

I'm intrigued as it isn't too long ago I told Steve G in one of his "gloomy" predictions that there would be an upsurge in sightings and sighting reports in the run p to SUFOG's Open Day November 2nd! Much else under the paranormal umbrella is also going on!

This may NOT be "The END" but will do for now! Any subsequent or stop press items notwithstanding!

**UFO MAGAZINE** has two "bumper" issues to hand... September and October... both have impact in their two different ways... and, yeah!... "THE TRUTH IS COMING" as the glossy cover tells us! The September issue also tells us that "The End Of The World As We Know It"... I don't wish to know that. Much more interesting is the "Police Officers Who Observe UFO's"... written by DC. Gary Heseltine from "information received"... loads of detailed encounters from fellow officers over 8 pages! Enough evidence to hang all sceptics! Bets selling author Nick Redfern, now domiciled in the USA, takes us on a tour of modern day Roswell. Nick Pope gives us

the low down on Crop Circle history and much more over 5 pages. Russian cosmonauts and senior military men speak out on the reality of UFO's. Add Rendlesham, British encounters, that 1990 Tornado incident, new data, and much more, Not forgetting the spotlight on our own SUFOG and it's members and eleven years of its history!

October and UFO Magazine repeated its expertise with some very interesting stuff... I was quite intrigued by the interview with Seth Shostic of the astro. Based S.E.T.I... especially his attitude to UFO's which he was eventually quizzed about by Graham Birdsall! Letter to Graham on that. Splendid item by Lucy Pringle and her 30 odd photos of crop formations and opinions and theories. A lady who's been "in it" almost as long as I have and who is very conversant with the "spiritual" side and sticks to her guns. That Tonbridge, Kent, UFO photo as revealed in the Press... see cuttings. Oodles of British sightings and encounters. War-time Fighter Command chief Lord Hugh Dowding's newly discovered notes... not widely known he was also a spiritualist. His superiors kept that very quiet! Big article on the Brazilian's First International UFO Congress which Graham Birdsall spoke at shows how advanced that country is on openness about the phenomena. Says much that a top Brazilian airline part sponsored the four day event! Get your DOUBLE issue of UFO Magazine for November/December on sale at £3.50 special price, end of October. Back to normal £2.50 in January at the better newsagents or subs.

**OVNI.** July/August issue from Derbyshire's Omar Fowler is as ever a good read... those Flying Triangles (FT's) are being reported in more locations and with more frequency than is generally realised to quote Omar. Such reports take up the first page... two good ones from Melbourne, Derbyshire, descriptions backed by witnesses drawings. Bonsall of 2001 fame again sees a UFO as a hazy yellow slow moving light in March this year. Bright glittering "golden" object near Buxton June this year. Another Belgium triangle "flap" going back to 2001 gets a space in OVNI. George Filer's Files has USA reports for June this year. A strange Dutch cornfield formation reported in June this year. Melbourne in the news again with a Derbyshire driver being followed by an unidentified object in 1992 included a Kodak employees story about a 'room full of such photos' as the car driver reported seeing. Graham Birdsall UFO Magazine Editor and colleague Russel Callaghan held a public meeting mainly for Bonsall

residents to put the record straight. Omar Fowler also spoke at the meeting, held on the 26th June. BBC Radio Derby covered the meeting and issued a written report on it's web-page. OVNI is the Journal of the Phenomenon Research Association and is £1 a copy, bi-monthly, from 94 The Circle, Sinfín, Drby, DE24 9H.

**BUFORA JOURNAL...** Norman Oliver's New BUFORA Journal arrived during September... better late than never, two more planned to catch up with long delays this year. Good to see Norman's editorial allowing for the more esoteric aspects of UFOlogy, such as "channelling" and other psychic matters. Many of us have been working in those wider fields for years without compromising the UFO aspect. My occasional talks always include examples from my experiences. Well produced and printed magazine, includes old encounters, an interesting photo feature, reports, points from the Press, investigations diary, lectures update and visiting subjects etc. Some material needs updating... especially the comment of 'sightings falling'... after all this was the Spring issue! A very long running organisation, BUFORA has long held the post of being first call by the media on incidents. London office for enquiries : BM BUFORA, London, WC1N 3XX.

**AWARENESS...** The Journal of the Contact International UFO Research... Summer 2002 issue... articles on "rods, spirals, and balls", News in Brief, a third visit to the Public Records Office at Kew by Geoff Amber, Tony Broad and Mike Soper, says security tight, the UFO brochure hadn't been updated since their last 1999 visit. The 1967 and 1971 reports studied under the 30 years rule. New "spiral" photos make interesting reading... suggest Awareness tries Psychic News for latest "spirit" photos! "Mothman" connections with Cornwall phenomenon? "Death of UFOlogy"... a personal view of Un-convention 2002... well, we all know about that one by now! The UFOlogy Phoenix has risen AGAIN! Awareness Magazine printed and published at Po Box 23, Wheatley, Oxon, OX33 1FL. 01869 320989.

**AUSTRALIAN UFO BULLETIN** of the Victorian UFO Research Society under the

Presidency and Editor Judith Magee is always smartly produced pocket sized magazine which covers many areas apart from Down Under ! Their members include pilots!... understandable since they meet at the Royal Victorian Aero Club. Good advice follows from Paul Norman who writes on the 1950 Washington DC "flap" and the more current sightings in Australia which seem to be more dramatic and profuse than over in the UK and, indeed, other countries. Paul concludes by suggesting we forget the ridicule of the cynical sceptics who haven't studied the UFO subject... my own outlook... for many years and a common fault with such people. Unexplained lights in the sky... up to 30 in number!... are puzzling residents in a Grampian, Victoria, valley. Videos and even the Herald Sun newspaper have been involved in filming these. Reams of video footage are available. Police report sightings... one made two officers jaws drop as it hovered and then shot off near Mildura in May of this year. George Filers Files cover many pages in the magazine... mostly USA based but other countries too. 


I think so!


o of pl e, b hey, do i ve ... I certainly felt like it by 12 a.m. As the day was not due to finish at 9 p.m, it was going to be a long day.

began, and is possibly the reason why we don't behave as other animals (Mammals) do. I'm being brief here.

You will notice also that there are other objects within the Rock painting , This Ancient cave painting at Fergana in Oezbekistan, could be a key and also a possible location point to those concerned with following up with further research to the Crabwood case.

As I write this newsletter, I had decided to cancel our open day in November. This decision was not taken lightly, and what follows are the reasons why :

Up until the 6th of October 2002, we have sold only 3 tickets. Within the next three weeks we would of had to of sold 60 tickets and hope that a further 20 people turned up on the door.

The group funds are not brilliant (We only have £100 in reserve).

If we do not raise £400 by the 2nd of November, the group would have to find the shortfall and to be honest, the group would be bankrupted. The money would have had to of come from my own pocket and I certainly cannot afford it. Would other group members put their hands in their pockets and chuck £30 or £40 in to save the group from bankruptcy. ?

There has been, up until the 6th October only 1 group member that has purchased a

ticket out of a total membership of 34. And again, if ALL 34 people bought tickets, that would raise £204, and with £100 in reserve, we would still be around £200 short. We would need another 34 people to turn up on the door.

Also, a number of people have said that they will be attending, but I cannot take that as gospel, as this has happened so many times in the past, and people have not turned up. The hall holds over 200 people and if we only had 30 people there, then I would feel sorry for the speakers and SUFOG also be embarrassed. Also, if the press were to turn up and only 30 people were in the hall, then again SUFOG would be humiliated by the press.

I know that this is going to upset a small group of members, and I am sorry if it does. If people feel strongly about this, and they wish to leave SUFOG, then again, that is your prerogative. I have to think of the group and if it means the group folding due to yet another venture falling flat on its face, then the group comes first. If members are not happy with my decision, then all I can say is that I am happy to close the group completely and end it there.

If any group member has paid for posters, advertising, photocopies etc, then the group is more than happy to refund the money.
