


So, if you feel that you want to help or have any other ideas for the group, then please let me know.




Invention: Flying Saucer Is Out Of This World.

There are some strange goings-on in a small Peterborough workshop.

Mysterious flying saucers seen around the city have pricked the curiosity of secretive US defence officials.

A group of dedicated space enthusiasts at GFS Projects Limited - which stands for Geoff's Flying Saucer - have been tinkering away with some alien designs in their own Area 51 in Saxon Road.

For six years, Geoff Hatton and his team have worked tirelessly to take a giant leap into the unknown and created six realistic flying saucers.

And now the uniqueness of the machines, which can take off vertically, fly, hover and land, has attracted the imagination of the American officials who went to see if the truth really was out there.

Like a scene from the X-Files, the men in black flew across the Atlantic to check out the UFOs and see if the truth really is out there.

But what the US officials want with the mysterious machines remains Top Secret. Geoff, of Eastfield Road, Peterborough, who was celebrating his 67th birthday on Monday, said: "It is extremely pleasing to have anything you do recognised by other people.

"It was an exploratory meeting set up by a third party. After the meetings I had the impression they were pleased with what they had seen. We will just have to wait. I have no idea what they want them for."

UFO-spotter thinks Spinnaker Tower has become an alien tourist spot

A UFO spotter is convinced aliens have been hovering near Portsmouth's newest tourist attraction.

Ernie Sears believes an alien craft has been drawn to the tower out of curiosity - but he has been told it's more likely to have been a plane.

Mr Sears said: 'We can only

speculate but I think the Spinnaker Tower may be attracting curiosity from alien life.

'They want to know why it has been erected and what it can do for them.'

Mr Sears, 81, said he was told by a Gosport resident that the bright, cigar-shaped object remained in the sky for

a few minutes before vanishing.

Mr Sears, of Rotary Court, Netley Abbey, said: 'It was a cigar shape, rounded at both ends, glowing and has several black globes around it.'

It is the second UFO sighting in the area reported in *The News* in recent months.

In September, we revealed how Martin Pragnell, 38, was amazed to capture a picture of a strange object in the sky as he was trying out his new digital camera in the garden at his home in Priddy's Hard, Gosport.

And Mr Sears, who runs the Southampton UFO Group,

said there had been about eight or nine UFO sightings over Portsmouth Harbour in the past few months.

It is a significant rise in the number of south coast sightings reported to the society, which also investigates other paranormal phenomena, such as crop circles and ghosts.

ERNIE TELLS OF HIS CLOSE ENCOUNTER WITH LITTLE BLUE CREATURES ON BOARD UFO

I WAS ABDUCTED BY ALIENS

THE truth may be out there, but Ernie Sears still hasn't discovered what that is yet, despite his numerous extra-terrestrial experiences.

He claims to have witnessed a dozen unexplained sightings, an alleged military cover-up, and even openly declares that he's been abducted himself.


The sprightly 81-year-old is also the main spokesman for the Southampton UFO Group, a band of spotters who like to investigate UFO sightings.

Disappeared

When Ernie saw his first UFO back in 1960, he didn't realise it was going to change his life.

He revealed to *The Weekly News*. 'I was an insurance agent and was just doing my rounds in Gosport one cold morning, when I saw a shining object glinting in the sky over the Admiralty Surface Weapons Establishment, which is nearby.'

'I thought it was just a plane, so didn't worry about it, but then I heard the sound of approaching air force jets which came flying towards the object.'

'Sir, you didn't see any jets and you didn't see any object'

disappeared over the top of the row of houses.

It returned the following night but, although I was ready with a camera, none of the pictures came out well.

But this second time, one of the lights flashed down and hit me. In the next instant, I felt like I was in the solar system, looking past Mars and the other planets.

'I can only remember going to the UFO and back, but not what actually happened onboard.'

'I remember seeing lots of little blue aliens that were quite rubbery creatures, and certainly not frightening.'

'They took me into the ship which didn't have doors, but was entered through this jelly-like substance. They were being watched over by a grey alien with big eyes and sloping face.'

'It felt very real.'

Encounter

'I have to accept the fact that I believe I've been abducted. I have a scar on my wrist that I can't remember ever occurring.'

'I also remember having a vision of seeing big tanks like test tubes holding hybrid alien humans that were glowing.'

'I can only explain these things as I remember them,' said Ernie. 'I don't know what it all means, and it really doesn't bother me if people don't believe me.'

'I DO believe it and, when you have a one-to-one encounter like I have, it's very convincing.'

'When it happens, you become more aware of a great, big, awesome situation in advance of us - both spiritually and scientifically.'

'As these pictures here show, there's something in the air that's obviously alien.'

UFO HUNTER CLAIMS THERE'S BEEN A GREAT MILITARY COVER-UP

The hub-cap like machines look like they've been lifted from a '50s B-movie. They glide gracefully through the air using the Coanda principle, which involves jets of nozzled air being attracted to a nearby curved surfaces.

To date, all the prototypes have been battery-powered, but GFS believe larger versions could have proper internal combustion engines. Geoff, who first came up with the plans for the saucers while sitting on his dining room table, added: "We are the only company in the world doing this sort of thing. The future is shaping up to be very promising indeed." Shane Miller (24), of Parnwell, Peterborough, is the youngest member of the team. He said: "When I first saw the saucers when I started last August, I simply said 'wow'." The team are not relying on the outcome of the visit from the American government - as the company is constantly dreaming up new ways of marketing the saucers. They believe the flying saucers can be adapted as toys, to aid mountain rescues, land mine detection and even as a state-of-the-art scarecrows. To set the ball rolling, the company secured a £43,000 SMART grant from the Department of Trade and Industry and equity funding from a group of investors. The saucers range from 10ins to three feet in diameter.

'Four dull lights' seen over city

LAST year, a UFO enthusiast planned to use the Freedom of Information Act to access previously secret Government documents to explain sightings of flying objects around Peterborough. Michael Hoffman, of Bruces Close, Conington, near Peterborough, who runs the UFO research group Sky Lights, hopes that the release of so-called "X files" held by the Ministry of Defence (MoD) will finally shed light on why there have been so many alien sightings in the area. He said: "I think the Act will give us quite a lot of information about UFOs, and it is something our group will definitely use." The MoD recently released secret papers under the Act showing that 91 sightings were recorded last year in the UK, including a report of "four dull red lights" hovering above Peterborough.



UFO Sighting Claim - Watch The Video..

A Crosland Moor woman has captured images of a strange object in the skies above Huddersfield. Now she is hoping someone can identify the object, which she saw on Monday afternoon.

Teresa Millward, 28, of Crosland Moor, said: "It was very strange and slow-moving. It was shaped a bit like a triangle. "I watched it travelling into the distance over the town, then it returned and seemed to move sideways." She added: "I thought it was a hang glider or a balloon, but when it came closer I could see it was neither of those things."

Teresa photographed the UFO using a digital camera and recorded its movements on video. Teresa, who is in a wheelchair while recovering from an accident on holiday in New Zealand, described the sighting as "very unnerving". She said: "I am not a believer in UFOs, but I have no idea

what this was.

UFO Enthusiasts Gather In Forest..

More than 100 people are expected to gather in a Suffolk forest on Tuesday night to mark 25 years since a famous UFO sighting.

During the nights of 26 and 27 December 1980, US servicemen at RAF Woodbridge and Bentwaters reported mysterious lights in Rendlesham Forest.

The strange lights included a glowing metallic triangle and a hovering object with red and blue lights.

UFO enthusiasts are hoping there might be more sightings during the night.

Brenda Butler, a local resident who has written about the events of 1980, believes the sightings of 25 years ago were real.

Patrol car lights...

"People who were coming up the Butley Road and who were in Woodbridge, Melton, Leiston and all around the area saw structured craft," she said.

"And that's not the first time - we can go way back to the 1600s and we've had lights in the sky and in the forest." In 2003, Kevin Conde, a former US security policeman said he had been responsible for the lights in the forest.

He said he and another airman shined patrol car lights through the trees and made noises on a loudspeaker as a prank. "We just drove through the forest flashing the lights through the fog," he said.

Despite Mr Conde's claim, some witnesses do not believe they saw patrol car lights in Rendlesham Forest.

US Air Force Sergeant John Burroughs said: "The blue lights coming down from the sky... I still have never heard of any technology capable of doing what I saw happening."

The Lincolnshire Echo : 05 January 2006...

Are Aliens Watching Us?

Spooked residents claim to have seen alien spaceships hovering over Lincolnshire.

Two groups of people, who have all denied being under the influence of alcohol or drugs, said they saw the UFOs on December 30 and 31.

They both claim that glowing objects hovered over them for a few seconds and then silently disappeared.

No official radar records exist for the dates in question as RAF Waddington's air traffic control centre was closed.

And the police say that they have received no reports of other sightings.

But Beth Clarkson (58), of Dene Close, Skellingthorpe, is convinced that she saw a UFO. She was at a caravan convention at the Memorial Hall in Wellingore when it happened.

"It was about 5pm on Saturday. I was fetching some water for the van with another man when he just gasped and pointed to the sky. There was this orange cone shaped object burning in the sky. It hovered for a while and then headed off towards Waddington. There was no sound, it was really eerie." Mum Sandy Gregory of St Peter's Avenue, Boultham, Lincoln, had a similar experience the next day. "My family and neighbours were stood out front at about midday and the strangest thing flew past at about tree height. It was like a plate with a flame on it and it was going at about 20mph," she said. "Then it flew over Boultham Park and went towards the city. We don't know what it was - and no we weren't drunk."


In May last year the Echo used the Freedom of Information Act to access information on UFO sightings across the county. Documents revealed that six unidentified flying objects had been reported in Lincolnshire's skies over the past five years. Flight Lieutenant Roger Steel, who works in air traffic control at RAF Waddington, said: "We only started operating the radar again yesterday and it was out of action from December 21 for Christmas so we have no records to check whether we picked anything up or not. "There are a number of possible conventional explanations. "Obviously it could be aircraft. Since the opening of the new Robin Hood airport there's been a lot more activity. And there is also the possibility of the Humberside Police helicopter. This uses a powerful search light that creates a column of light. And the sound of the helicopter can often be blown away if there is a stiff breeze."

Lincolnshire Police spokesman Tony Diggins said the force had received no UFO sighting reports over the festive season. "And to our knowledge the Humberside chopper was not out."

In the know Under the Freedom of Information Act the Echo received details of all official UFO sightings reported to the military over the past five years.

The records show six sightings involving seven objects reported to personnel in the county. All of the sightings were made by residents or motorists who claimed to have seen unexplained objects. But no reports explaining the sightings or showing the results of further investigations into their authenticity have been released. The sightings include reports of objects shaped like triangles, torpedoes or even cylinders. Others were recorded as "glowing" and "lights" in the night sky. The objects were reported to hover in the air, move silently, race across the sky and even spin. One "speeding light" was said to have "turned 180 degrees back on itself instantaneously".

Another was reported to have hovered in the air before it "shot off creating a blue and white light some 30ft long". In November 2001 a resident of Gonerby, Grantham, reported that his house had started to shake and had experienced a power cut when a "glowing object" appeared over it. MoD records report the caller seeing what "looked like a missile" moving very fast. "Caller believes it could not have been an aircraft as it did not have wings," read the report. At the time the RAF reported no flights in the area.

GUARDIAN (The) 6th February... US Serial Number Gives Clue To Mystery Of The Alien In The Attic...

When Barney Broom began renovating his cottage he did not expect to be confronted by a pair of black eyes staring from a cloudy jar.

But the mysterious discovery of an alien in his attic has spooked the 54-year-old screenwriter and bewildered extraterrestrial experts, who yesterday suggested the US military could be involved.

The delicate 30cm (12 inch) figure of a baby alien is stored in a pungent liquid and has a US serial number painted on its four-toed foot. Possibly sculpted from a clay-like substance and painted grey, the model closely resembles the aliens depicted in a hoax film of an autopsy of the infamous "Roswell incident".

Curiously, the alien was discovered stored in an old toffee jar wrapped in a copy of the Daily Mirror dating from October 1947. In July of that year, officials at the American air base of Roswell reported and then denied finding the remains of a flying saucer. The Roswell incident sparked a popular fascination with UFOs and led the US air force to collect data on sightings.

One theory is that the alien was left in the loft by a US serviceman working at a nearby US air base. Mr Broom's two-bedroom cottage at Gunthorpe, north Norfolk, which he bought eight

months ago, is 45 miles from two large US air bases at RAF Lakenheath and RAF Mildenhall. Many US servicemen and women live and work in the region.

Mr Broom told the Guardian he was "a bit spooked" by the discovery but said he was not yet living in fear of being beamed up by aliens.

"It was stuffed in the corner of the loft with other old newspapers. Before me, an old spinster lived in the house. I don't think anybody had been up there for years. I haven't got three heads and I'm not the sort of eccentric lunatic to think it's an alien but it's a funny thing to find in your loft."

Mr Broom reported his finding to the Sci Fi Channel, who called in Professor Adam Roberts, an expert in science fiction literature, to examine the creature.

"The easy thing to do is dismiss it all and say it's a hoax. It may be or may not be," said Prof Roberts. "The fact that it was found near a US air base suggests there may be a military component to it."

A spokeswoman for the US air force said it had never made such models of an alien, the figure was not government property and the serial number could mean it had been catalogued by a museum. "It's a hoax," the spokeswoman said.

Prof Roberts admitted it could be a film prop dating from the 1960s, but said he was not surprised at US denials: "That is the US air force line. They deny these alien encounters. It is quite possible they concoct stories to cover up for more nefarious activities."

The Sci Fi Channel will this week broadcast live footage of the alien on its website. After further tests, Mr Broom will put it on his mantelpiece.

On November 11, 1987, Edward Walters, a local building contractor, was working late when he noticed a light outside of his window. Peering out, he saw a glowing object partially hidden by the 30 foot pine tree growing in his front yard. Ed went outside to investigate and was afforded a much better, if not stunning view of the unworldly object. He described seeing a top-shaped craft with a row of dark squares with smaller "portals" between them. The object, with its bright, luminous ring around the bottom, hovered slightly above the road. He quickly returned to his house and grabbed his Polaroid camera. Walters took several pictures from his front yard and decided to go into the street for a better view. While standing in the street the object began hovering directly above him. Walters claims that a bright blue "beam of light" shot out of the craft, stunning him as it raised him several feet off of the ground. He heard a voice exclaim "Don't worry, we will not harm you". He then described seeing images of "dogs" flashing in his head "just as if they were turning the pages of a book". He then awoke and the UFO was gone.

Sceptics still doubted Walters claims and on February 18, 1988 and February 23, 1988, Ed was given two polygraph tests by Harvey W. McLaughlin Jr. He was also given a battery of psychological tests by Florida clinical psychologist, Dan Overlade. Walters passed the polygraph tests and the psychological profile indicated no personality abnormalities.

A model spaceship resembling the UFOs reportedly seen above Gulf Breeze has been found in a house once occupied by the man whose photographs started a UFO craze that has focused worldwide attention on this community.

Hampshire Sightings:


Around late July or Early August 1967, me aged 10, my sister aged 9 and my mother were in our back garden, in a small town called Chandlers Ford, about 10 miles from Southampton, in the South of England.

We all noticed a silver disk, just hovering in the sky, it was there for around 40 minutes, not moving, then it slowly started to descend, my sister and I noticed it was approaching the ground, no more than a mile from our location, and being children, immediately decided to go and investigate.

We crossed 2 roads, and headed for open fields, where we believed the disk had landed, upon crossing the field, we entered a small wooded area, not very large, perhaps 200 meters wide, as we came out of the other side of the wooded area, right in front of us, no more than 10 feet in front of us was a silver disk craft, just hovering around 10 feet of the ground.

The next thing I remember, its much darker now, the sun has gone, and the craft is still just hovering in front of me, it slowly starts to rise into the sky, at around 60 feet above me, the craft became very bright then went straight up, within a second or so, it became like a small star, a tiny dot in the sky, then it was gone. This craft clearly went straight into space, and made the journey from 50 feet, to orbit in under 2 seconds, it was a very clear night sky.

I then looked down at my feet, there was a circle in the crops, only a few feet in front of me, it was perfectly round, about 40 feet across, there were no tracks to the circle or within the circle, it was not there the day before. (Early Hampshire Crop Circle?)

However.. 


If you look at these images, there seems to be a solid body to them, with a very thin rippling 'wing' going down both sides of the

Lt. Walter Haut, Spokesman Who Announced Wreckage Of Flying Saucer In Roswell, Died At 83..

By Associated Press... ALBUQUERQUE - The man made famous for issuing a news release that said a flying saucer landed in Roswell has died.

Army Lt. Walter Haut, a former spokesman for the Roswell Army Air Field, died Thursday in Roswell, his daughter, Julie Shuster, said. He was 83.

Haut listened closely on July 8, 1947 as base commander Col. William Blanchard dictated a news release about a recovered flying saucer and ordered Haut to issue it. The Roswell Daily Record newspaper ran a bold headline July 9, 1947: "RAAF Captures Flying Saucer on Ranch in Roswell Region." The same day, a statement was released saying it was only a weather balloon. "I guess they changed their mind," Haut told The Associated Press in 1997.

Haut said he never was told exactly where the flying disc reported in his news release was found nor did he, himself, ever see a UFO. But he remained a believer.

"There must have been something in the skies at that time," he said. "There's just too much evidence."

Haut and two other men founded The International UFO Museum in 1991 where he was president until 1996. More than 2 1/2 million people have visited the museum since it opened in 1992, Shuster said.

It wasn't until the late 1980s that Shuster said she and her sister learned about the flying saucer incident, not from their father

but from a book.

"It was not a topic of conversation at the dinner table for anybody involved," she said. Haut, born June 3, 1922, in Chicago is survived by his two daughters, Shuster and Marabeth Fields of Roswell, three grandchildren & four great-grandchildren.

A viewing is scheduled Monday in Roswell at the LaGrone Funeral Home. Funeral services are set for 11 a.m. Tuesday at Trinity United Methodist.

A bus travelling from Cordoba to San Luis was forced to stop due to the presence of a flying saucer on the road. A passenger says everyone got out to take a look at the phenomenon

A woman claimed having seen a UFO last Friday on the route linking the province of Cordoba with San Luis, while she travelled as a passenger in a microbus belonging to the Andesmar Company.

The passenger said that during the night, the bus stopped on the road facing an enormous light and that other passengers and drivers got out of the vehicle to witness the event.

"The time was 21:45 and the bus suddenly stopped. Upon looking down the aisle, I noticed a huge light in the middle of the road. I immediately jumped out of my seat and saw something that I will never forget: a

cone-shaped light in the middle of the road," the passenger told the El Liberal newspaper.

Later on, the woman said that she felt herself overcome by a sensation of peace and curiosity, to the extent that she began taking photos of the object with her digital camera.

"Suddenly, the object was enveloped in a bluish-white light and started to spin like a top and rise straight up, lighting the landscape like daytime. In the measure that it ascended, it issued coloured lights in intense phosphorescent shades. It suddenly disappeared to become a glowing dot. I immediately began perceiving an odour of heated metal that blended with a very particular smell resembling sulphur," remarked the traveller.

Chinese City To Build
UFO Research Centre.

GUIYANG, China, Dec. 6 (UPI) -- A Taiwanese company has put up \$20 million to build a UFO research base in China's southern province of Guizhou, where aliens are said to have visited in 1994.

Residents of Baiyun district in Guiyang, the provincial capital, hope the institute will look into the odd phenomena they experienced Nov. 30, 1994, Xinhua reported Tuesday.

On that date, nearly 70 acres of pine trees on a tree farm mysteriously fell down, while nearby plastic shelters remained intact.

A truck factory reported steel pipes strangely broken, a huge truck moved

more than 20 yards, and a night shift employee pulled into the air by an "unknown force."

Local residents attributed the odd occurrences to UFOs, but scientists sent to investigate blamed them on thunder, lightning and tornados.

Wang Fangchen, a biologist who visited the site shortly after the reported events, called the UFO research plan "ridiculous," but said he would not oppose it if it would attract tourists to the city.

Zhou Xiaoqiang, secretary general of the Beijing UFO Research Association, said people often mistake planes, clouds, insects and shadows for UFOs. "If aliens really came, they would more likely appear before our eyes politely than hide themselves," he said.

China Strange Craft Causes Near Miss...

Bohai Sea -- Recently, China's CCTV reported that six Chinese Air Force pilots of the Flight Performance Teams witnessed a large unidentified aircraft formation flying toward them resulting in a near mid-air collision. Air traffic control radar systems were unable to observe and/or record the unidentified formation. On the CCTV program "Approaching Science", Feng Yi, deputy team lead of the Chinese Air Force Flight Performance Team, a top level pilot with 3,000 hours of flying experience, talked about this unusual experience.

Feng and his team were conducting the performance training over the Bohai Sea. At 9 a.m., the flight team reached an altitude of 21,000 feet. Suddenly a large unidentified formation of planes appeared just about 30 miles left to them flying from southeast to northwest. Feng

reported this observation immediately to the Air Traffic Control Centre and requested them to conduct a search, but no other airplanes were reported on radar. Feng's team mates have also seen the same aircraft formations.

The airplanes both he and his team have seen, all represented different countries from different periods of history. Propeller types as well as jets had been included in the formations. It is highly unlikely that all of the pilots had the same illusion at the same time. Some experts believe perhaps it was a scene from another dimension or even another time.

China has the largest Air Force in the world with over 6,000 planes.

X-Files Revealed: MoD Has UFO Log...

Spooked residents have reported seeing mysterious UFOs in the skies above Harborough and Lutterworth, the Ministry of Defence has revealed.

A large black triangular aircraft with three bright lights was spotted above Harborough's skies at 2pm on Friday, January 9, 2004, according to MoD documents disclosed under the Freedom of Information Act (FoI).

The strange object was also said to have made a rumbling noise.

It is not the first time mysterious objects have been spotted in Harborough's heavens, but it is the first time the existence of such sightings being logged in Government files has come to light.

In 1996 and 1997 scores of people reported seeing strange objects in Harborough in nine separate incidents. About three years later, in 2000, there were three more reports of UFO sightings.

The MoD said a witness also spotted a UFO with flashing lights in Lutterworth on Monday, September 20, 2004.

UFO enthusiast Gary Anthony (40), of East Yorkshire, who submitted the initial FoI requests to the MoD, said: "In 95 per cent of cases UFO reports can be put down to a natural or explainable phenomenon. In other incidents, there seems to be no rational explanation. I am not saying it's alien spaceships or flying saucers but these people have obviously felt scared enough to report the incidents to the MoD."

Insp Mick Norman, of Harborough police, said: "People do occasionally report this type of incident to the police as a first port of call.

"Our response is very much dictated by what the individual thinks they have seen. "People can be confused sometimes when aircraft is heading in their direction because it can appear as if the lights are remaining static, when in fact they are moving very quickly."


Minutes for the meeting December 2005 and January 2006.


