Nick Pope, former UFO desk officer at the MOD and author of several UFO books argues that interest in UFOs is returning.

UFOs Are Back...

UFOs are back. After a period when interest in the subject had waned, the topic is suddenly generating a vast amount of media coverage. So what's going on and what are the implications for publishers and authors?

First of all, I should declare an interest. I used to run the British Government's UFO Project at the Ministry of Defence. I've written four books on the subject, all of which were agented (can I use a noun as a verb if my editor isn't looking?) by Andrew Lownie.

Interest in UFOs is cyclic. The last peak came in the mid-Nineties. In 1995, the so-called 'alien autopsy' film was

released: grainy black and white footage that some said showed a vaguely humanoid extraterrestrial being cut open by US military surgeons. Believers claimed this was the proof they'd been waiting for, while sceptics said that the film was a clever hoax. 1997 saw the 50th anniversary of America's first 'flying saucer' sighting and of the Roswell incident, where something (alien spacecraft or weather balloon, depending on who you believe) crashed in the New Mexico desert. Publishers, the media and the public were intrigued by all this and numerous books appeared. They did well. Authors such as Timothy Good were on the bestseller lists and my own first effort 'Open Skies Closed Minds' got to number three in the hardback non-fiction list and stayed in the top ten for ten weeks.

However, in publishing as in economics, every boom is followed by a bust. The market was saturated and the view was that publishers had overbought. Interest in UFOs fell away, replaced perhaps by an interest in magic. Flying saucers and aliens gave way to the fictional worlds of Harry Potter, Narnia and The Lord of the Rings. But now, things are changing. Perhaps driven by interest in Dan Brown's 'The Da Vinci Code', people are rediscovering their interest in real life mysteries.

Interest in UFOs is rising quickly and steadily. This is being fuelled by the Freedom of

Information Act - the MOD is being bombarded with requests for documents on UFOs, and a look at their website confirms this is virtually the most popular type of request they receive. The media have been quick to recognise the resurgence of interest. Over the Christmas period several national newspapers ran major features on the 25th anniversary of Britain's most famous UFO sighting, the Rendlesham Forest incident. Ant & Dec's new movie 'Alien Autopsy' is a fictional retelling of the story that sparked so much interest in 1995. Various UFO-related documentaries are in pre-production. But the real clue is in the way the subject is spilling out into a wider arena. The Science Museum have been running an exhibition about alien life, and my own recent TV appearances include not just documentaries, but popular entertainment programmes such as 'The New Paul O'Grady Show' and 'Totally Doctor Who'.

All the signs are there: the UFO is back. It remains to be seen how the publishing industry will respond, but I suspect the next few years will be an interesting time. Oh, and next year sees the 60th anniversary of the Roswell crash!

Andrew Lownie writes a monthly newsletter, which includes details of the Agency's latest news as well as advice for authors.

UK UFO Reports...

Project Condign - MOD UFO Study (New! Added 10 May 2006)

The Ministry of Defence has revealed details of a formerly secret UFO study. Codenamed 'Project Condign', the report is the most highly classified UFO document ever to have been released under the UK's Freedom of Information Act. Although I was involved in the discussions that led to the commissioning of this report, I had left the MOD's UFO Project by the time the study was undertaken and was not involved. I am certainly not the author, as has been suggested by various UFO researchers and journalists. The report runs to over 400 pages and delves into some fairly controversial areas, theorising about electrically-charged atmospheric plasmas, and temporal lobe disorders. The difficulty with this is that there's no scientific consensus on such matters, and as a rule of thumb, one shouldn't try to explain one unknown phenomenon by citing evidence of another! That said, the release of this report should be welcomed by all those with an interest

in the UFO mystery, be they sceptics or believers. It will further the debate on this issue and demonstrates the MOD's ongoing commitment to releasing as much UFO documentation as possible, under the Freedom of Information Act. The media are having a field day with this story, and I've been doing numerous TV and radio interviews. The UFO mystery is back in the spotlight and the release of this report shows that there were those of us in the MOD who believed that the UFO phenomenon was worthy of serious, in-depth study. The full report will be released on the MOD's website on or before 15 May.

May 5, 2006...

I was lying on a hammock in my back garden, making the most of a rare warm day for this time of year. I saw a small white ball at about 45 degrees moving quickly in an arc from north to south. The 'ball' slowed to a stop almost directly over my head and stayed in that position without any movement at all for about ten minutes. It then moved a few degrees south, then north, then south again. I lost sight of it when it disappeared behind some clouds. Based on observing aircraft (737 type) landing at the nearby airport at roughly the same height I would estimate the object to be quite small, maybe 10 feet across. There was no sound associated with the ball. I observed the object for twenty minutes and saw a Tornado fighter jet pass low over my position. UFO Cannot Believe It!

A space odyssey of UFO sightings has been zooming across our radar courtesy of eagle-eyed readers.

Your calls flooded in after Pip Neal spotted a mysterious green ball in the sky over Southcote on Friday, April 7, and Vicky Chapman saw a glowing red orb over Basingstoke Road on Good Friday (Post, Wednesdays, April 19 and 26, respectively).

It's not the first time Mr Neal has seen unexplained things in the sky. He also told us that he saw a triangle of

light in the skies over Lincoln two decades ago.

Gloria Fisher, a carer from Meadow Road, Earley, called to say she and husband, Roy, a window-maker, spotted the same phenomenon, also 20 years ago, while camping in Wittering, Sussex.

She said: "We looked up in the sky and saw a triangle of white light as though joined but you could see through the middle. It was in complete formation but whether it was a Government experiment, you just don't know.

"We haven't really mentioned it too much to people. "My husband, if you do see things, says it's probably clouds or aeroplanes and the last thing you think about is UFOs but you do think: 'Ooh, I wonder'." Peter Brake, 77, revealed his experiences after reading about the Good Friday sighting in the Post. "The first one was mind-boggling, like a world just going along," he said of his sighting of a multicoloured globe while in his Whitley Wood garden some years ago. "It wasn't smooth, it was like in a square pattern and lit up. I didn't know quite what to make of it. "When it got level with me it was there one second and suddenly went away from me within two seconds." Then last September the retired forestry worker spied a deep red star-like object moving slowly over his Falmouth Road garden. But perhaps the most exciting phenomenon has been by former coffee shop worker Janet Cryer, from Woodley who witnessed a bright, whooshing light roaring past her first-floor window. She couldn't sleep at around 1am on Tuesday, April 18, when suddenly she heard a noise "like an underground train, a roar and a whoosh at the same time" before a greeny-coloured light flew past her open-curtained window. "Immediately I thought it was a meteorite and I was waiting for a bang," said the 58-year-old. "It was faster than a helicopter and nothing like an aircraft. The day after that I saw all those stories in the paper." Mrs Cryer, of Hanwood Close, added: "My late husband used to long to see a UFO, he used to keep all the clippings."



MAIL ON SUNDAY... 16th April : ET, Shine Home...It appears that Steven Spielberg has 'seen the light;' and is backing the search of space for 'Flashes of Light' that may be carrying messages from ET! He is a fund raiser for the Planetary Society that is funding a £200,000 telescope in Massachusetts that will be used to detect rays of light possibly carry an ET signal.

THE DAILY MAIL and it was Monday May the 8th and the post plasma story was breaking with the reaction to the Ministry of Defence Freedom Of Information with the "explanation" from various "experts" that UFO'S were 'no more than glowing balls of gas!' PSYCHIC NEWS 20TH May had an interesting front page article which said that a well known medium had been called in by a panel of interested people to look into the possibility of trying to get in touch with the mysterious man whose body had been found on top of a mound of coal products at the village of Todmorden in Yorkshire. His body had strange marks on it, particularly at the back of his neck, which appeared to have sustained a burn type wound. The incident made the Sunday papers since his surname was Adamski! World News & UFO Reports...

The Finnish Air Force made an important disclosure presenting a video of an incident involving a military jet fighter and a UFO. According to Tapani Koivula, chairman of the Finnish research group FUFORA, the encounter took place on April 27, 2005 and it was recorded by the infrared camera aboard the fighter.

There was another UFO incident also recorded on November 2003 and both cases were disclosed by the Finnish Air Force. Researcher Tapani Koivula received the files and footage for further analysis.

In his report Mr. Koivula mentioned that, "No normal explanations have been found, neither by officials nor UFO researchers". The Mexican Air Force UFO case was discussed by them as the UFO event was also recorded on infrared camera while flying over the Campeche aerial space.

This is an important advance in the efforts for a global UFO Disclosure by the military institutions all over the world.

My daughter and I were driving northbound on Manzanita Avenue at about 9:50 PM, on May 12, 2006. We were approaching an intersection to come to a stop when we saw very chaotic flashing deep red and brilliant white strobe lights in front of us. They were in the north sky. 'UFO Car' Beams Into Spotlight...

Producers from History Channel to visit historical museum today... By Susanne Nadeau

Late one August night, almost 30 years ago, a mysterious flash of light bore down on a Marshall County deputy as he was patrolling the western edge of the county.

The light lasted only a few minutes, before Sheriff Deputy Val Johnson, who was driving along Minnesota Highway 220, lost consciousness of time.

A few minutes grew into half an hour - 40 minutes, before Johnson became aware of the night again, and when that happened, damage had been done to his eyes and his squad car.

The cause of the light has remained a mystery since August 1979. And it's been the subject of much speculation. Enough speculation to draw the occasional interest of publications and television producers, according to Ethel Thorlaciuss, the director of the Marshall County Historical Museum.

Today, Thorlaciuss said, producers from the History Channel will be visiting the museum, which houses the squad car Johnson was driving that night.

The car retains unusual damage, she said, from a broken headlight to a long dent in the hood, a hole in the windshield and an antenna bent at a 45-degree angle.

It's become the county "UFO car", though Thorlaciuss said there's no way to know what caused the damage.

"I believe that there was something outside that car that was responsible for the damage", Thorlaciuss said.

A UFO, a ball of lightning, St. Elmo's fire, all come up on Thorlaciuss' conjecture list.

"You would have to see the damages to understand how unusual they are", Thorlaciuss said. "It's, well, it's like something went right over it, rolled over it."

Maybe she'll never know how the damage occurred, but she will have many more opportunities to discuss it as interested parties come through to talk about it.

"I know there are a lot of people who believe that nothing really different happened", she said. "It's controversial, just like anything about the unknown."

SUFOG is now exchanging publications with the UFOlogist magazine in Australia and we are in the process of exchanging approx. 40 back issues of each publications...

UFOs Exist - It's Official!

The MOD has today published the results of a once-highly-classified official investigation into the existence of Unidentified Flying Objects. The report concludes that UFOs exist - but are a mixture of natural and man-made phenomena, rather than evidence of extraterrestrial life.

The report examines 'UFO' sightings collected over a 30 year period, to ascertain whether there is any evidence of a threat to the UK and to identify any potential military technologies of interest. The study was not conducted to substantiate the existence of extraterrestrial life-forms but we can confirm that no such evidence was found.

As for 'UFOs', or Unidentified Aerial Phenomena (they're not always objects), the report concluded that while people reporting sightings are often genuine, rational explanations such as aircraft lights or natural phenomena, including meteors forming 'buoyant plasmas', can explain them.

The report concludes that none of the UFO reports the MoD received had any Defence Intelligence value and led to the decision in December 2000 that the Defence Intelligence Staff no longer had any need to continue receiving UFO sighting reports.

Under Secretary of State for Defence, Tom Watson said:

"I am delighted that the Freedom of Information Act has meant that this once Secret report has been declassified and made public. In a department where lives are literally on the line and we can't release every document we have, this is yet more

evidence of the MoD's commitment to openness."

The study, titled Unidentified Aerial Phenomena in the UK Air Defence Region, was conducted between 1996 and 2000 during a policy review into the handling of UFO sighting reports by the MOD. The report contains sensitive information concerning the UK Air Defence Region and was therefore classified Secret and given a limited distribution. Until the introduction of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, all government records were closed from public viewing for a period of 30 years after the last action was taken.

The report has been released now because MoD received a Freedom of Information request for a copy of the report. Embracing the spirit of open government, and despite the size (over 450 pages) and original classification staff have taken great care to ensure that the majority of this large report is made available.

There is a real and enduring interest in Unidentified Flying Objects. By far the most popular topics of FOI requests has been UFOs, followed by Recruitment enquiries; enquiries from staff; and historical events such as World War Two, the Falklands conflict and the Balkans. Recent FOI MoD releases on UFOs have attracted media interest from as far away as Japan.

The West Kilbride UFO Hotspot case solved?

I was reading the 'Alien invasion of UFO Hotspot West Kilbride' article on pages 7&8 of the Mar/Apr 2006 SUFOG newsletter taken from 'The Scotsman' (To recap, in the article dated Thu 2 Feb 2006, it said "reports released by the Ministry of Defence (MoD) revealed that West Kilbride had the highest number of recorded sightings of flying saucers in Britain during 2004"), when I remembered researching 'Bonnybridge' a year or so ago and thought that honour went there, indeed a quick search uncovered a quote from the very same publication on Thu 8 Apr 2004 stating; "Its official - Bonnybridge is the UFO capital of UK". according to Nick Pope who ran the UFO desk at the MoD between 1991 and 1994".

Anyway, what's more important to me than 'The Scotsman' making their mind up on the precise location of the actual holder of the 2004 UK UFO Hotspot (a quick bit of research will show that these two places are only 40 miles apart anyway, and are in an area called the "Falkirk Triangle" which is responsible for most of the 300 reported UFO sightings in Scotland a year) is why people should be baffled by UFO sightings in this area. The publication goes on to say; "For many years, it has been clear something strange has been going on in this small community a few miles from Falkirk, and quotes Stirling-based UFO writer Ron Halliday as saying "But it does seem to be a bit of a mystery why Bonnybridge should be a

target of spaceships from other planets." Even the late Graham Birdsall, former editor of UFO magazine, said: "UFOs tend to be attracted to regions that are fairly remote, plus, if you have a remote area, look out for airbases - Scotland is littered with airbases."

In my opinion (and am I the only one here?) they are all overlooking something very obvious, which is that UFO's often appear near Nuclear Weapons facilities. indeed, the MOD's own website states "submarines armed with Trident nuclear missiles provide the nation's strategic nuclear deterrent". And where do you think the base for these submarines is? Its HM Naval Base at Faslane, which is on the river Clyde and approximately equidistant between West Kilbride and Bonnybridge. Of course these sightings could be merely a coincidence? The good old 'Scotsman' goes on to remark "West Kilbride had a total of 12 sightings during 2004, which makes it Britain's closest rival to the UFO capital of Roswell, New Mexico." Now, I always thought that honour went to the 1980 Rendlesham Forest incident, and it was regarded as the 'British Roswell' because that they both undeniably issued (actual but quickly covered up) military reports of crashed/landed UFO's.

Interestingly though, is that in July 1947 when the Roswell UFO crash was reported, the 509th Bomb command based at Roswell (and the home of the Hiroshima and Nagasaki bombers) was the only nuclear air group in the world. And in the 1980 Rendlesham Forest incident, which happened over the joint UK/US RAF bases of Bentwaters and Woodbridge, was also where US nuclear bombers were stationed. On the subject of the many recent UFO

sightings over Portsmouth Harbour, a quick search on the internet reveals that Portsmouth Naval Shipyard "has become a leader in the repair and overhaul of nuclear-powered submarines (and presumably the ones carrying Trident missiles) and the three birthing dry-docks are capable of docking all active classes of submarines in the U.S. Navy, for overhaul and nuclear-reactor refuelling. So, I wonder if this could be the reason why UFO's seem very interested in this area also?



There were 2,123 sightings of big cats between April 2004 and July 2005, with the South-West the hot spot for sightings. Dorset and the New Forest have provided a steady stream of sightings, with Dorset police logging about 30 calls a year by 2003.

2006 Crop Circle Formations...

Conondale Crop Circle Queensland, Australia, 2006 AUFORN QLD report by Robert Frola...

Its been 2 years since the last set of crop circles appeared in a private paddock [field] on Aherns Road on the way to Crystal Waters on a Sunday afternoon March 28th 2004, found by local boys, Eli Colbran and Tom Braby while out bushwalking.

Today we have a new set of circles one large & one small and the question on every ones lips, are these man-made or were they made by a UFO observed in the area around the same time, who knows? But AUFORN will travel to the area this week to continue their investigation.

For those interested, Mrs. English called AUFORN to have a chat about the circles on her property.

Phone interview with Robert Frola AUFORN Qld

Q: Robert asked Mrs. English if she had seen the crop circles from 2 years ago.

Mrs. English said "I was aware of the previous circles which appeared on the Aherns road property in 2004 but at that time we were away in Emerald, central Queensland, where they had 4 or 5 circles appear. We only have 2".

Mrs. English said "they don't appear to be man-made but we don't know....I can't see how they could be man-made but that's all we know. They're just there".

Mr English said: "We didn't discover them, someone else did and they passed this information on to someone who knew someone who was into UFOs. His name was Chris and he rang my mother in-law and asked if he could take a look. He took measurements and 7 photos".

Comment: Robert informed Mrs. English that TV coverage could stir quite a bit of interest and she may get all kinds of people on your property wanting to have a look.

Robert also informed Mrs. English the previous land owner got very upset with people continually climbing his fence and trespassing on his property without permission and that he plowed the circles into the ground to stop interest.

Mrs. English said "I didn't want TV coverage but I'm quite happy to let those that have a keen interest in the circles take a look".

Comment from Channel 9 TV: The reason we were in the area was because we had a team up in Maleny covering the opening of the new Woolworth's store. It was just good timing.

Mrs. English tried to think of what or who could have made the circles and informed AUFORN she believed in the possibility of life out there in the universe.

Mrs. English said "we really have no idea what's done it, certainly we haven't done them and it seems unlikely that someone else would come into our place and do them. I don't know if there is any technically way or who would do it". "There's no holes in the middle" indicating if man-made, then maybe there should be, "but there is a slight cone of grass in the middle of one of the circles and we did have 2 reports of people who reported seeing something in the sky at about that time, over 2 nights".

Mrs. English said "the circles had been there since Thursday that she is aware of, but they could have been there longer as they were only found this Thursday 30

of March.

"The lady who lives across the road who I don't know and have only met today, she was on TV. She saw something in the sky and heard lots of noise. My goats freaked out and they wouldn't go away from the house for a couple of days. I just thought there could have been dingoes around and maybe that's what upset them. I didn't know about these crop circles at the time. Whether that's connected or not I don't know".

Mrs. English said: "This fellow Chris and his wife and mother in-law saw something hovering about that time also, and the lady across the road reckons she saw something, but we my husband and I didn't hear anything at all".
