

### SUFQG Membership to increase in 2007...

Over the years, SUFQG has been able to subsidise the magazine at £6.80 per member. BUT, to continue bringing you the continuing

quality of the magazine this has to change. We have seen a large rise in production costs in ink (Now have to use Epson cartridges and not cheaper ones as the printer heads block up), paper and postage. We have not passed this onto members, but I am sorry to say, we can no longer afford to do this. On page 4 I have given you a breakdown as to how much the magazine costs to print etc so that you can see :

1. We have a potential deficit of £155.00 for 2006/07.
2. Each magazine costs £2.80 to produce, post etc and therefore :  
 $£2.80 \times 6 = £16.80$ .

We can no longer afford to subsidise the members to the amount of £6.80 every year and it is starting to show in our funds. We are not in this to make money and if there was any other way to avoid this I would do it... but there isn't. Therefore as of the 1st January 2007, Subscriptions will be rising to £15.00 per year.

There is a possibility that we will lose members, but what will be will be. I hope that members will still continue to support the group rather than see the publication go under and eventually see SUFQG itself go under. So please, bear with us through this difficult time and I can assure you, the quality of the magazine will not diminish and it is hoped that it may

possibly grow in strength. Without the members and their support, the group has no future.

### UK UFO Reports...

Nick Pope on the BBC World Service, 25/9/06, being interviewed about an article published in The Guardian Newspaper (See Newspaper Reviews) that day which disclosed that the MoD had considered avoiding disclosure of the participation of DI55 in the investigation of UFOs in excess of the minimum 30 year period as would be required by the Public Records Act at the time.

*Interviewer:* Now some people swear they have seen one or maybe more, others think it's a lot of nonsense. Well whatever your opinion on UFOs, it has emerged that the British Government took them very seriously - so seriously that it had a special unit set up to investigate them. Secret documents released under the Freedom of Information Act reveals the extent of these investigations and the extent which the Ministry of Defence went to cover up the activities of that special unit called DI55. It's almost X- files. Well, Nick Pope ran the investigative department of the MoD between 1991 and 1994 - what did he do?

*Nick Pope:* My job was to research and investigate the sightings reported to see if there was evidence of any threat to the defence of the country.

*Interviewer:* And why did the Government take such an interest to the extent of setting

up a special unit?

*Nick Pope:* If we have reports of unidentified craft operating in our airspace, clearly we want to know what they are and what they're doing. Many of these UFO sightings involve reports from credible witnesses such as police officers and pilots. UFOs have been tracked on radar, and they've been seen performing at speeds and manoeuvres that seem to go way ahead of that we've got, so of course that's got to be of interest to us.

*Interviewer:* So how did you investigate?

*Nick Pope:* It's essentially a process of elimination. Most UFO sightings are going to be well-intentioned misidentifications of ordinary objects and phenomena, so you look to see if there was any civil or military aircraft activity, you check with the launch positions and times of weather balloons, you look at satellite data, you talk to astronomers to see if there was any astronomical object or phenomena that might explain what was seen, you can look at the radar tapes, if you are lucky enough to have a photo or video you can get that analysed.

*Interviewer:* So how often did you find a rational explanation for what was seen?

*Nick Pope:* Well I received about 2 or 3 hundred reports each year, and I reckon of those about 80% of them I could explain to a high degree of satisfaction. About 15% there really wasn't enough information to come to a firm conclusions. The remaining 5%, genuinely interesting, and those were

the real UFOs as it were.

**Interviewer:** And what is your theory about those?

**Nick Pope:** I don't have one because they are still unknowns. As to whether they could be extraterrestrial in origin, I can't rule that out.

**Interviewer:** You will of course realise that there will be many people listening to this thinking all of this is just crazy. What do you say to them?

**Nick Pope:** Well I've been accused of various things - some people think that the whole idea of looking at UFOs at all is a complete waste of time and money. UFO enthusiasts think that there's a sinister cover-up and I've been accused of being a part of that. All I can say is that when I was doing my job, I did it to the best of my ability, investigated any sighting reported to me and did my best to come to a conclusion.

**Interviewer:** In these files that are released at the moment, they describe the extent to which the government tried to cover up the existence of this special unit which investigated UFOs. Why do you think they were so keen to cover it up?

**Nick Pope:** I would dispute the phrase "cover up" - just because something is downplayed, does not mean it's a vast conspiracy.

**Interviewer:** And does this unit still exist?

**Nick Pope:** The UFO project that I was involved with is still there, but now it's really responding to Freedom of Information Act requests. It's the number 1 subject that people write to the MoD about.

**Interviewer:** And that was the man who ran the UFO investigative department for Britain's Ministry of Defence between 1991 and 1994. That was Nick Pope.

### Strange Lights Give Driver A Fright...

A Suffolk teenager got the fright of her life when her car was chased by floating lights as she drove across the Orwell Bridge.

The 18-year-old, who has asked not to be named, was driving home to Saxmundham from Bury St Edmunds at about 4 am on Saturday, August 26.

As she drove over the Orwell Bridge she saw two spinning lights about 12 feet ahead of her.

They remained in front of the car as she drove, and worried her so much that she was distracted and missed the A12 turning at Seven Hills.

She said: "I carried on to Felixstowe and the lights stayed with me until I turned around at the Trimley roundabout. I've never been so scared."

The teenager said they hovered above her windscreen and were a dull colour, not shining particularly brightly.

She added: "They definitely seemed to be staying with the car."

The motorist had not realised anyone else had seen the lights until she saw a letter in The Evening Star last Friday.

She said: "It sounded very like what I saw. I have no idea what they were, they really spooked me."

She was on her own the car and was very relieved to reach home in Saxmundham.

Last week Heidi Garwood of Fletcher Road in Ipswich wrote a letter to say that her father had seen some mysterious lights in the Nacton Road

area of the town at about 4.30 am on the same day - and she had heard similar stories from other people in the area.

The sightings come more than a quarter of a century after east Suffolk was at the heart of one of Britain's biggest UFO mysteries after US servicemen reported strange lights in the sky near USAF Woodbridge during the Christmas period in 1980.

**Mystery After UFO Sighting...**

In a scene reminiscent of the X Files, a couple have been left scratching their heads after a UFO sighting in their garden.

Helen Hanreck, 49, was looking for her cats in the garden when she noticed a bright light in the sky.

Miss Hanreck, of Longwalk, Istead Rise, claims she saw more than six red lights moving silently across the night sky.

She claims the lights were moving slowly in an inverted V shape with a long tail.

The insurance manager called to her partner, Nick Claydon, to have a look at the spectacle on September 8 at 9.45 pm.

Miss Hanreck says she hoped he would give her a rational explanation to the unexplained lights.

She said: "I thought it was flying too close to other aircraft and I did think it's a terrorist attack heading for London'.

"But then I realised it was going the other way and heading south east. I called to Nick as I thought he would know what the lights were as he has a pilot's licence.

"But when he came into the garden we were both lost for words.

We watched the lights for 10 to 15 minutes and it was like watching Chinese lanterns being dragged silently through the sky."

She added: "I am not a believer in spaceships and

aliens but I called the police to report it.

"They told me a taxi driver had already phoned in about it, so I was relieved it was not just us."

Mr Claydon, who also saw the UFOs, insists he and his partner are not "nutters".

The 49-year-old said: "We are not flying saucer nutters. We are just normal people, although we did go to Roswell in America to see where a spaceship was supposed to crash.

"I have always wanted to see something like this as other people go on about it.

"When we saw it I raced for my camera but I had it on the wrong setting so nothing came out."

Miss Hanreck says there may be a perfectly logical explanation although she can't think of one.


She added: "I would be interested to hear whether anyone else saw anything.

Is There Anybody Out There?  
How The Men From The Ministry  
Hid The Hunt For UFOs...

- MoD tried to cover-up secret investigation unit- 10,000 eyewitness reports 'mostly due to weather'

Ministry of Defence went to extraordinary lengths to cover up its true involvement in investigating UFOs, according to secret documents revealed under the Freedom of Information Act.

The files show that officials attempted to expunge information from documents released to the Public Records Office under the "30-year rule" that would have revealed the extent of the MoD's interest in UFO sightings.

In particular, the ministry wanted to cover up the operation of a secret unit dedicated to UFO investigations within the Defence Intelligence Staff. UFO conspiracy theorists have likened the unit, called DI55, to a sort of "Men in Black" agency for defending the Earth against invasion but the released documents show this is far

from the truth. One 1995 memo from DI55 to the MoD's public "UFO desk" said: "I have several books at home that describe our supposed role of 'defender of the Earth against the alien menace' - it is light years from the truth!"

The files were made public following FOI requests by David Clarke, a lecturer in journalism at Sheffield Hallam University and his colleague Andy Roberts.

"These documents don't tell us anything about UFOs but they do show how desperate the MoD have been to conceal the interest which the intelligence services had in the subject," said Dr Clarke.

The trail begins with a request, in 1976, from a UFO enthusiast called Julian Hennessy for access to the MoD's records on UFO sightings. A note from the UFO desk to the MoD's head of security on March 23 shows that officials intended to refuse him access on the grounds that the files contain confidential information and "very little of value to a serious scientific investigator".

But the note continues: "This is not to say that the investigation is not taken seriously. The branches have their own methods - and [the public UFO desk] has no 'need to know' about them - but we are aware that DI55 for example sometimes makes extensive inquiries.

"It is undesirable that even a hint of this should become public and we are currently consulting the [Air Historical Branch] on ways of expurgating the official records against the time when they qualify for disclosure [at the Public Records Office]."

Hearing of the background to his fob off 30 years ago Mr Hennessy, who is a local magistrate, was not surprised. "Everything led me to believe there was a major cover up going on," he said. "They didn't want to let the public know just how interested they were in these

phenomena."

Attempts to alter the public record went on into the 90s. In a note dated April 28 1993 from DI55 to the public UFO desk the unnamed author argued the unit's involvement should be excised from records due to be released under the 30-year rule. But the cat was already out of the bag. A clerical error in 1983 had meant that the distribution list was incorrectly left on a publicly released UFO-related document, so UFO enthusiasts were already asking questions.

"Since then they have obviously been bombarded by people saying who is this DI55, what do they do, what is the extent of their involvement," said Dr Clarke.

Eventually, DI55 decided to allow its involvement to be made public. A note from DI55 to the public UFO desk on 5 July 1995 said: "I see no reason for continuing to deny that the [Defence Intelligence Service] has an interest in UFOs. However, if the association is formally made public then the MoD will no doubt be pressured to state what the intelligence role/interest is. This could lead to disbelief and embarrassment since few people are likely to believe the truth that lack of funds and higher priorities have prevented any study of the thousands of reports received."

At this point someone, presumably from the public UFO desk, has scribbled "ouch!" in the margin.

"The lengths they went to remove any mention of the Defence Intelligence staff's central role in investigating sightings suggests they had something to hide," said Dr Clarke. "But what they were hiding was not evidence of ET visits but embarrassment at the fact they were never allowed to spend public money on

investigating the subject in any depth." The full extent of DI55's involvement has subsequently been made clear by a report released to Dr Clarke in May and reported in the Guardian. That threw up a 500-page document which brought together everything the unit knew about UFOs, or Unidentified Aerial Phenomena (UAPs) as the MoD prefers, including more than 10,000 sightings. It said the existence of UAPs was "indisputable", but blamed the most vexing sighting on airborne "plasmas" formed during "more than one set of weather and electrically charged conditions", or during meteor showers.

#### Sighting aliens or otherwise?

August 10 1965 A man reported seeing a crimson ball fly out of the side of a hill in Warminster, Wiltshire. A fortnight later, another man photographed a UFO in the centre of Warminster. In 1994 it was claimed the photo was a hoax and the object was made from a cotton reel and a button.

Boxing Day 1980 A UFO reportedly crash landed in Rendlesham forest, Suffolk, near the Woodbridge US air force base. The incident was nicknamed Britain's Roswell in a reference to the famous UFO sighting in New Mexico in 1947. Witnesses said the craft was covered in markings similar to Egyptian hieroglyphs and aliens emerged from it. An airman later confessed the incident was a hoax.

November 28 1980 Policeman Alan Godfrey reported seeing a six-metre wide dome-like object hovering in the air in Todmorden, West Yorkshire. He returned to the site with colleagues and they found the area where the object

had supposedly been hovering was dry even though the rest of the road was wet because of earlier rain.

Early 1990s A string of sightings by residents in north Scotland of a UFO regularly flying overhead at great speed. Documents released earlier this year suggested the aircraft was a spy plane called Aurora, designed by the Americans to take covert pictures of the Soviet Union.

May 2006 The MoD released details of Project Condign, a four-year secret study into possible explanations for UFOs. The report concluded that many sightings could be explained as by glowing "plasmas" of gas created by charges of electricity.

It so happened that the dramatic two page article in the good old

**DAILY EXPRESS** of Tuesday September 8<sup>th</sup> led into smaller items that caught my attention so instead of that one only so here goes.:

Gigantic headline "THE UFO CONSPIRACY" raised my hopes that here was one of those "leaks" that are badly needed. The previous day's **GUARDIAN** had much the same except for the UFO photo over the House of Commons and the subtitle in the **EXPRESS** that ran; 'New evidence reveals that successive Governments have details about 'alien spacecraft' to protect the public. But if there's nothing to worry about why is it also secret?'

Good start, eh? PC Alan Godfrey was pictured with blackboard drawings of the 'aliens' that had abducted him in 1980. Better still! Ex MOD's UFO deskman Nick Pope got off his regular fence...carefully... and wonders if there isn't a more troubling reason at the root of the attempted MOD "whitewash" if the existence of an

extraterrestrial life was conclusively proved.. or disproved" and 'the most profound development for the human race, outside proof that there is a God'. Where has Pope been all this time? A vast majority of mankind.. experiencers, abductees, military men, pilots et al have accepted such for years and watch the "proof" building up. So we KNOW why the authorities FEAR disclosure. We know of their GUILT a our world heads for disaster in several ways. DR David Clarke... him of that "plasma" crap and subsequent cowardly return of the photos I sent him, he evaded those by claiming 'not known at this address'. Hallam College was contacted by our brave leader Steve and confirm the good (?) doctor was still in residence there. Who can trust Clarke anyway, a "professional sceptic" in FEAR of losing his status, job, etc. OK...you hopefully get the picture. Don't hold your breath. THE TRUTH IS COMING! From.....

**THE TIMES** ran an interesting, I think, series of LETTERS to the Editor, on for instance, the paranormal and the attitude of scientists and science towards such... issues between September and October. Brief excerpts from such as "Science resists the unknown" (three long letters) and "The paranormal must prove itself to science" (three against the paranormal and one for) plus a beauty of an article by "talking to plants" author/investigator Rupert Sheldrake.. His research into unexplained human abilities funded by Trinity College, Cambridge. His article was amusingly (but totally correct to many of us) "Gosh, I was just thinking about you" Subtitled; If you think

telepathy is tosh, many scientists agree with you. But they ignore the evidence. THINK about the times when YOU think about someone and either they are then on the phone to you, or you bump into them somewhere, or whatever Sheldrake suggests this is because. MIND Sare more extensive than brains.

Also in THE TIMES in September a tiny paragraph says: 'We are not alone and informs us that 'earth-like planets around distant stars are much more common that scientists had thought. American astronomers have found more than a third of 150 solar systems detected beyond our own are likely to have small planets suitable for life. While another newspaper (unknown) on the same 8th September date reports that Chris Thomas, of the University of York, claims earth, by the end of this century, will be hotter than in the previous ten millions years. Fifty per cent of equatorial species have already moved to colder climates.

THE SUNDAY EXPRESS provides a suitably ironical closer to this review with it's own review of a new book, THE CREATION, headlined with "Plea to save the world from homo sapiens". **26th September 2006...**

**Close Encounters At Marion...**

UFO sightings in South Australia have taken off, with dozens of people reporting close encounters to the Australian Cosmic Connection hotline.

ACC director Kevin Robb said extraterrestrial encounters in the state were "going crazy", with Waitpinga, Semaphore, Kangaroo Island and the Adelaide Hills the top places to spot ET activity.

"Sightings are coming in all the time, from north to south to east to west," Mr Robb said.

"There seems to be a glut of it at the moment."

Silver discs, strange flashing lights and cigar-shaped orange craft are among the sightings reported to the 24-hour hotline.

Hundreds of people are expected to discuss the phenomenon at a UFO evening tomorrow night at the Marion Sports and Recreation Centre. Registration begins at 6.30 pm.

UK author and UFO expert Timothy Good will be the guest speaker, and will launch his book *Need to Know: UFOs, the military and intelligence*.

Daily newspaper Slovenske Novice  
(Slovenian News)...  
28th August 2006...

Retired, 78 years old lady Marija Adam from small city Novo Mesto (Slovenia) describes, that on Saturday on 22nd July 2006 at close to 4.45 in the morning saw something over some treetops like a shine.

Her first impression had been that she saw a fire. She watched for longer time, when horizon had been lighted by glowing sky body, which emitted a special light. Body had a shape of circle and big like small saucer and bigger then stars or artificial satellite.

It slowly drifted across treetops and then slowly moved toward east. She watched phenomena till 5. a.m., until daylight and then it vanished.

She then each morning waited for eventual reappearance, but no luck. Then it reappeared again on Sunday on 20th August 2006, when she saw it again, after one month. It had the same size, was blinking and described as a little darker then stars.

Palermo -- Several reports from local residents reveal the presence of lights and unidentified objects in September 18, 2006. The UFOs appear to sympathize with certain politicians and campaigning seasons. The photo of the municipal representative ratifies other accounts from peasants and villagers. For fifteen years, sightings occurred around Palermo, where they have given rise to surprise, admiration, fear and stories that range from absolute belief to the most forceful

scepticism.

Some say that the UFOs have political sympathies, because they are mostly seen when elections are taking place or the day prior to voting. Juan Alberto Bernal, 37, a resident of Palermo saw the UFO and states, "It would be very selfish to believe that in such a wide universe, a small planet like ours is the only one harbouring life. Fifteen years ago I saw three strange objects with lights on Cerro El Baché. One crossed, the other descended and they zigzagged around.

Sixto Francisco Cerquera, Neiva's former mayor, saw them. He was campaigning for a seat in the Huila assembly, and observed the phenomenon with his wife. He says, "When we moved the car, the light followed and that night, the lights went out when the object stopped over the town church." The lights were restored to the town immediately when the object before vanished." Juan Alberto Bernal recalls that a peasant witnessed the landing of a vehicle for the current candidate for mayor of Neiva. Three shining men descended from the object. Halifax, Nova Scotia -- I looked out the window on a clear morning at 5:30 AM, on September 11, 2006, and saw a strange light in the sky over Bedford Basin that was changing colours from white to blue to red randomly. Also it seemed to move side to side and up and down in a way that no airplane can move. We watched it for

about a hour and a half and it was moving randomly around in a small area of the sky at a very high altitude, much higher than planes fly. What this was I can not say. I took 5 pictures of the sky and with my computer I zoomed in to see a fuzzy blue thing.

**Aldergrove, British Columbia** -- I saw a UFO shaped like a football hovering very low to the ground on September 11, 2006, from 8:15 to 8:30 PM. I got in my car and followed it. It was very bright in the centre and it went so slowly at first. When I lifted my camera (digital) to take a picture, it would not pick it up on the camera at all. It picked up speed very quickly and flew towards 264th and 0 avenue in Aldergrove B.C. I saw it at 232nd and 32nd Avenue. The lights were mostly clear with a green one and red, but the inside was so bright, florescent.

**Caledon, Ontario** -- Numerous photos were taken of a UFO sighting on August 2, 2006. My wife and I went for a drive into the badlands in Caledon to take pictures of the moon. We arrived at about 7:40 PM. It was still light but the moon was very bright. So we picked a clear view and set up the tripod. I started to take pictures and I got some very good shots. About 9:45 PM as we were leaving there was all kinds of commotion in the trees and bushes. It was dark and I could not see. I got spooked my closed the windows locked the doors and got out of my Dodge. When we stopped at shoppers drug, I downloaded the pictures to an AVR and I had captured a UFO. I said that must be why I got spooked. I said can't wait to see these on the 53" TV. I scanned through 14 pictures of the UFO. One just starting to break the atmosphere, two fully engulfed in the atmosphere. Three cooling down. Four it's sitting still, five it's leaving

going back to space. So I seem to have proof that we are being visited by crafts from space and aliens.

**Mexican Pilot Reports UFO...**  
**The Journal of Hispanic Ufology...**  
**October 7, 2006...**

According to a report by Mexican researcher Alfonso Salazar, Captain Luis Guillermo Cruz, first officer of a Boeing 737-200, registration XA-MAR, reported a tubular unidentified flying object with a metallic appearance directly over Lake Tequesquitengo in the Mexican state of Morelos.

The sighting occurred on September 16, 2006 at 14:00 hrs. during a flight from Huatulco to Mexico City along air corridor L-47. Weather conditions were clear with some clouds.

According to the witness, he was alerted by an intense reflection visible four miles away from the airline, toward the right side of the cabin. At first he thought it could be a glider, but as they approached, he had a clear observation of an unknown object.

He added that the tubular flying object crossed at the same altitude the airliner was flying but in the opposite direction and with a north/south trajectory, remaining a mile and a half distant from the airliner.

The object vanished 4 minutes later.

**Book Reviews****By Ernie Sears (SUFOG PRO)...**

Having had a couple of books to review for sometime as well as Timothy Good's current one I feel like making a clean sweep today so here goes!

**CONSPIRACY OF SILENCE**, subtitled **UFOS IN IRELAND**, by Dermot Butler and Carl Nally, is 240 pages long in a neat paper back product and goes into great detail on how UFOS have been sighted in Ireland for hundreds of years in some form or another. People who have had no previous interest in such phenomena have reported bizarre experiences and encounters with the paranormal in almost every county from Derry to Cork, Dublin to Galway.

Dermot Butler and Carl Nally have certainly put any discerning reader in the simply amazing picture, that quotes a mass of UFO reports from a wide range of observers, that includes pilots, engineers, who have hitherto kept a strict silence. Of course, SUFOG members are already aware of Dermot and Carl via the pages of their ever thickening UPRI NEWSLETTER, that I review on a "swap" basis, and I had some idea of the extent of the Irish sightings and encounters. However, the book is an eye opener! A forward by Timothy Good and chapters that speak for themselves (Not just lights in the sky, Irish UFO Research-a history, North of the Airfield, Altered States and Abductions, Mysterious Munster, Strange Island, UFO Crash in Roscommon, and Official Interest. The books contents feature dramatic accounts of MANY incidents concerning civilian aircraft and unknown flying objects, some of which caused alarm and actual damage to the planes.

But, well-known investigator Margaret-Ellen Fry has had a 155 page paperback since 2004 and it's a mine of in your face sightings and actual encounters, some multi witnessed and much more. The title poses the question "WHO ARE THEY", there's a foreword by the famous sidekick of George Adamski...Desmond Leslie wrote the best selling book on Adamski's amazing claims of meeting a man from space.

Sadly, following others we miss like hell in the UFO field, Desmond passed away just before Margaret's sequel as part of her Link to the Stars in which he was due to write another introduction to Margaret's intention to divide the books into two. She was educated by nuns in the Himalayas before she was forced by the independence of India to return here and settled at an RAF station in Lincolnshire with her parents, later on moving to Kent where her story begins. In July 1955 where extraterrestrials made themselves known to her and many friends! In the early 1970's the first Victim Support team was formed in conjunction with Alan Hilton, who had had alien experience too. I spoke at Alan's pleasant little sanctuary in Kent a couple of years ago over an autumn weekend in the

company of prestigious Investigators and experimenter, one being the late civilian pilot Graham Sheppard.

Margaret asks questions in her excellent book such as 'does the UFO phenomena latch on to certain families for generations? Are they in our reality? Who are these alien Beings? Where do they come from? Consider that all this is happening worldwide. Read this book and realise it could happen to you!'


Well, I read Margaret's book although already being predisposed towards YES answers to the foregoing, based on my own experiences. However, this lady has had encounters, some multi-witnessed, that beat mine hollow! Notably the really CLOSE encounter she had in company with a doctor who was driving her and her ill son to the surgery for medication. It was Sunday the 17<sup>th</sup> July 1955. A shadow engulfed the car. On a hot summers day the sun vanished. The car engine spluttered. Margaret asked if they could stop. The young Indian medic refused, saying he was no car mechanic. They turned into a side-road. The "shadow" followed! They stopped. Margaret and the doctor got out to see a grey cloud like oval about '18 feet over our heads' says Margaret... It began spinning and solidified as three ball bearing-like wheels came down. We were transfixed. The craft flipped on its side, then righted itself. Then it flopped down at a nearby crossroads and all on a quiet day in Bexleyheath, Kent. Margaret yelled to some children playing nearby. They came and stood with their mouths open around the craft! After a few minutes of being absolutely still, a few feet off the ground, the craft tilted and whooshed off to about one hundred feet when a "porthole" opened and the craft then ascended to 30,000 ft or more and the doctor (who kept repeating the did not believe in "flying saucers") and Margaret got back into the car and drove on to the surgery. Her sick son had been told to stay in the car but he saw the craft through the rear window. The car, by the way, ran perfectly. After Margaret's son

was treated at the surgery the doctor ran them back home. Some years later when Margaret decided to investigate their astonishing sighting, she found the doctor had reported the incident to the British Medical Board! No information came back! Interesting that the Kentish Times, a week following the incident, reported a policeman and other witnesses seeing a bell shaped craft low to the ground on the 17<sup>th</sup> July 1955! Her mother, who saw the report, and who never doubted Margaret's testimony, set about looking for a book on "Flying Saucers" and latched onto Adamski's "Flying Saucers have Landed" as a birthday present for Margaret. As Margaret says in her book, 'One is never the same after such an event' She joined BUFORA in 1964 and met the Earl of Clancarty, (House of Lords investigator etc) and through him joined the Oxford based Contact International. Seems she still represents them today! Wonder if she is aware of Geoff Ambler's solution to George Warner's initial photo of that "cigar" with black "globes" encircling it as a 'high wing light aircraft!' Hmmm. In 1993 Margaret helped form the Welsh Federation of Independent UFOlogists.

I hope I've set the tone of the whole of Margaret Fry's well-thumbed paperback. As well as her own gripping UFO and allied experiences, she covers very well world events in UFOlogy, both in history and up to date incidents. A self produced Publication... she even shared the cover design with K.E. and J. Pepperell, simple but effective. Leaves me thinking afresh about my own thick and still unfinished manuscript, which needs a huge re-writing and re-thinking before long bearing in mind my 82 years! Money and TIME are the two main problems!

On the way there, at Km 277 of National Route No. 35, in the vicinity of Ataliva Roca, a Polled Hereford calf was found dead and mutilated. On the same route, but at Km 284, a red Aberdeen Angus cow was also found slain and mutilated.

At the "Mari Epu" ranch, located ten kilometres west of the Sierras de Lihue Calel, Puelches jurisdiction, a Polled Hereford bull was found dead and mutilated. Its owner, Bernardo Cueto, told researchers that the find was made known to the local police. The animal's death was estimated at

10 days ago.

The bovine was in good health and presented signs of mutilation in the lower right jaw, missing an eye and ear on the same side of the body, and was found lying on its stomach. Bernardo Cueto manifested surprise when he noted that "the animal appeared on a single print, pitched downward, lying on its stomach as if its legs had slowly given way."

On the return trip, and on the section of road between Quehue and the intersection of Routes No. 35 and Provincial Hwy. No. 18, Jorge Howe, owner of the "Los Corrales" ranch informed local police of the discovery of three black Aberdeen Angus cows, dead and mutilated.

MOOSE JAW (CP) -- A volunteer researcher with the Canadian Crop Circle Research Network says she's planning to check out some recently discovered circles in Saskatchewan.

Lois Baillie said she has been examining close-up and aerial photos of the circles and said they don't appear to have been man-made.

The impressions resemble two light bulbs connected to a stomach-shaped feature.

The circles were found on a pasture south of Buffalo Pound Lake in the Moose Jaw district. Baillie says both the light bulb shapes measure more than seven metres in diameter.

Theories about how crop circles form vary from extraterrestrial visitors and wind to human pranksters.

It's the first time circles have been found in the area in three years.

"It's different from most crop circles because it is open-ended. The formation of the open loop is surprising," Baillie said. "The grass movement was made from inside to outside or from outside to inside. It doesn't seem to be something humans could make."

Chile: Renewed Chupacabras Attack In Calama.

ORBE - (Calama) Some residents of Calama's Chunchuri Bajo sector are concerned following an alleged new attack

by the now-legendary "Chupacabras" after a number of animals appeared dead in one of the sector's plots of land.

Notice of the event occurred after a local woman heard strange noises on her rooftop. The next day she discovered that over 10 animals were dead in their pens.

The report was made by paranormal researcher Jaime Ferrer, who stated that this is not an isolated event, in his opinion. With regard to the aforementioned creature's attack, Ferrer explained that after becoming aware of the animal slaughter, he visited the site and interviewed the owner of Plot No.4. "What is strange about the affair is that if starving dogs had been involved, at least one of the animals would have been devoured. But quite the opposite occurred: no signs of bite marks or tearing could be found on the animals; one of the rabbits presented a deep hole on its left side, a trademark of a Chupacabras attack."

According to the information, the pen showed signs of having been ripped apart. However, no one saw anything on the night of the attack. Perhaps the only sign that something was amiss involved the behaviour of one of the small dogs owned by the affected Calama resident: the pet appeared grief stricken and even "cried" at times. The paranormal researcher stated that this is not the first time that this person has lost part of her animals to phenomena like this.

La Pampa -- The La Pampa Provincial Police and researchers from CIUFOS-LA PAMPA report: It was verified that in a

rural farm located in the vicinity of the "Padre Buodo" located in the Jurisdiction of General Acha, two black Aberdeen Angus heifers and a calf of the same type appeared to have been mutilated, presenting signs of bodily damage similar to others detected recently.

Another Black Angus calf was found dead and mutilated. A similar fate befell a cow found near Utracan. #### Beloit crop circle attracts attention...

BELOIT - Jane Wallace is careful to speculate about what created a large circle in her field of sorghum-sudangrass, but she is certain that it wasn't a UFO.

"We're just saying it wasn't man-made," said Wallace, Beloit. "We think was some other kind of phenomena."

Whatever caused the circle - 133 feet from east to west and 132 from north to south - it soon became a tourist attraction after it was spotted on Sept. 9 in a field 2 1/2 miles east of Beloit off Kansas Highway 9

"People just started coming by to see it," Wallace said. "It was all over town." And beyond town, too.

Word reached other states, bringing in crop investigators Rich Webb, Omaha, Neb., and Ted Robertson, Bloomington, Ind.

"We determined it to be a nonman-made

crop circle," Webb said Monday.

### Phantoms found at newspaper Office...

The offices of the Hampshire Chronicle have provided some spooky goings on for a team of television ghost hunters.

The group from the 'Phantom or Fraud' project spent the night in the listed building in Winchester High Street and came away convinced that it houses a number of spirits. The Newsquest title, which started in 1772, has been based in the High Street offices for almost 200 years.

The site it now stands on has a colourful history dating back as far as 1300 when a large tenement known as La Peryne stood on it. There have been a number of reported visitations from a ghost - usually that of a woman clanking machinery in part of the building that housed cottages and a small printing press until the existing premises were built in 1897. Chronicle sub editor Lesley Park is thought to have been the last to see the ghost - in October 2001 - causing some concern to more nervous members of staff. When 'Phantom or Fraud' offered to take a look around, the paper's editor, Alan Cleaver, invited the team of clairvoyants, sensitives and sceptics to stay overnight. He spent the night with the TV team, and said he wasn't surprised at the findings. He said: "I once worked on a paper called Psychic News and know full well that strange things happen in old buildings. "Perhaps we should consider a new initiative in starting up ghost tours of the building for the general public!"

Although they didn't actually see any ghosts, the clairvoyants are certain that a number of spirits are housed in the building. One of them is that of a man whose presence was traced in the editorial office. One of the sensitives apparently felt the presence of an undertaker with a coach and horses. And another could see a large building with a chapel. One of the team kept seeing chickens and animals in the staff training room. They appeared to be sedated as if in some sort of animal testing laboratory, while a lady in a white coat was also picked up. One of the clairvoyants picked up a pub scene in a part of the building that was actually a pub until around 1900 - although there was no tangible sign of any spirits.

# Twilight zone motors in on Gosport road

**MOTORISTS** in Gosport, Hants, are baffled by a 50-yard stretch of road where their cars refuse to start.

"Residents of Percy Road, Gosport, say 'unknown forces' are constantly shutting down their car immobilisers and electric starters," said "The News."

"Despite putting forward various theories, including new telephone masts, remote broadband installations and even MoD transmissions, they have been left scratching their heads at what is behind the problem."

Wayne Dobson, 38, first discovered the problem when he returned from work, parked as usual and tried to use a remote immobiliser on his V-registered Land Rover Freelander. There was no response.

After talking to neighbours, Mr Dobson discovered they had experienced exactly the same problem.

"It's all a bit Mulder and Scully," said Mr Dobson. "It's just these few car lengths outside our houses and started only at the end of last week. None of us

The RAC engineer reported that "the battery was fully charged, the car was fine and they could find nothing wrong with it," said Brenda.

### UFO Menace 'Not A Threat'

The Defence Ministry has denied that Britain is in peril from alien warships descending from the skies, while acknowledging that has received 714 reports of unidentified flying objects in the last six years.

Junior defence minister Derek Twigg said yesterday that of the 714 reports since 2001, only 12 had been 'deemed to be worthy of further consideration' - although he did not go into details of how the MoD decides if UFOs are potential battle cruisers from the Orion Nebula, or just funny-looking pigeons.

After further analysis, none of the 12 potential Betelgeusian Death Fleets were determined to 'demonstrate any threat to the integrity of the UK Air Defence Region'.

Mr Twigg's comments were in reply to Lynne Featherstone, the Liberal Democrat MP for Hornsey and Wood Green. The Wood Green area of London has long been believed to be a prime target for demolition by alien destructo-rays.

He added that: 'Reports (of UFOs) are analysed solely to consider whether there

is any reason to believe that UK airspace has been compromised by the reported activity.'

Earlier this year, another junior defence minister, Don Touhig, denied that the MoD had ever run a 'UFO project' - in other words, that any co-ordinated attempt was made to determine if UFOs were alien spacecraft. Rather, he also claimed that they were merely checked by desk officers to rule out the possibility that they - whatever they are - were violating British airspace.

So Britain remains safe from the threat of trans-dimensional super-villains raining fire and death from the heavens - for now. But can this lucky state of affairs last forever?

Hundreds Of UFOs In UK Skies...

More than 700 UFOs have been reported to the Ministry of Defence in the past six years, it emerged today.

The ministry has received 714 reports of mysterious flying objects since January 2001.
