UFO SIGHTING IN HALIFAX

Eleven year old Richard Stolly has reported the sighting of a UFO flying south over Halifax yesterday evening.

Richard, of 14, Heath Avenue, Halifax, saw the UFO at about 6pm & describes it as long & thin with a thin wedge on top. It was in sight for about 2 minutes, travelling slowly, before it vanished behind a cloud.

A mysterious flying object hovered over Peterborough
skies last night. Several people watched as the
flying craft, with red & white lights drifted gracefully
across the sky from Norman Cross & over the Ortons.
14 year old Andrew Wright watched with his girl
friend Jane Howe & her mother Mrs. Betty Howe as
the mystery craft hovered over the Norman Cross
Hotel.

"There were 2 large white lights at first" said
Andrew of Cherry Orton Road, Orton Waterville.

"They went out & 4 or 5 red lights came on.
When the lights went out there seemed to be a
greyish, square shaped object behind them.

"I have never seen anything like it before &
I am pretty convinced it was a UFO."
The UFO was also spotted by a housewife &
children in the Ortons as it came from the
direction of the A1.

And on Wednesday a motorist saw 2 white lights in the sky over the Deepings.

Stufsg Comment:- Almost certainly aircraft landing lights, & a Harrier Jump Jet from nearby RAF Wittering.

Washingbro Man claims UFO Visit. Lincolnshire Echo. 14.11.73.

Wood turner Mr. John Spalding claims he sighted a UFO hovering above Washingborough on Monday night (12.11.73)

From the garden of his home at 1 Lincoln Rd., Mr. Spalding (33) spotted a mysterious bright light moving across the southern sky from the direction of Bardney at about 10.30 p.m.

Silently, the star-like object then towards Washingborough at the speed of a jet, passed, moved a little way towards Lincoln & then stopped. It was still there when Mr. Spalding gave up & went to bed at midnight, he says.

Mr. Spalding had studied the light through binoculars, but the object was too high in the sky to make out an outline.

"All you could see was a bright light. It was much too high for a plane - & anyway they have flashing lights - so I thought it was

a satellite, until it stopped dead.

"People may think I'm barmy, but I know what I saw. The only explanation for that object is that it came from some intelligence outside this planet."

• Mr. Spalding says his wife & parents, who live nearby, also saw the moving light. Now he wants to hear from anyone else who spotted it.

He has twice before seen UFO's. The first, when he was 17, was a grey cylindrical object, which was also seen by his mother above Portland St., Lincoln.

3 years ago he saw a moving light, similar to Monday's sighting, above Washington.

Since his first sighting he has become a keen sky-watcher & a firm believer in UFO's.

* Former astronaut John Young says the odds are that UFO's do exist. Young, a member of the Apollo 16 crew, said: "It is mathematically improbable that there aren't other life sources in the universe."
