







Left. P. Moore and J. Burke - right - (BBC)



The most brilliant voyage to the moon ever, was the adventure of Apollo 15, and its crew - they brought back much more of the moon than previous missions. 
Mapping camera views of Hadley Rille and the Apennines. Left is a nearly vertical view, with Apollo 15 landing site marked by arrow

America's two remaining manned flights to the moon will fit into the basic framework set by the recent successful scientific mission of Apollo 15. The pattern of three periods of work on the moon will be followed, and no major changes of equipment are planned.

The crews for both missions have now been chosen, and it is known that Apollo 16 will be landing in a mountainous area called Descartes, 9° east 15° south of the moon's centre. The target for Apollo 17, in March 1973, has still to be chosen. It will be selected on the basis of data obtained from Apollo 15.

The success of the Apollo 15 mission has prompted project officials to take a second look at a number of sites for the final lunar landing. The crater Alphonsus is the most likely candidate, but a number of others are still under consideration, including areas near the sea of Crises and the crater Gassendi south of the Ocean of Storms.

Because the Apollo 17 crew will include a professional geologist several accessible areas which could be scientifically productive are being studied by means of Apollo 15 photographs and other data received from orbit.

If the decision is eventually made to attempt a landing inside the deep Alphonsus crater the astronauts may be able to recover early lunar rock from the crater walls.

MASSES OF DATA

The Manned Spacecraft centre at Houston is inundated by the

mass of data returned from Apollo 15, and officials there are delighted with the scientific return from the mission.

The 170-lbs of rock samples, which include more than 60 sizeable pieces, have provided scientists with a much wider variety than those returned from earlier missions,

THAT MYSTERY ROCK

While the so-called Genesis Rock is probably not, as the scientists first hoped, a fragment of primeval lunar material, the samples together represent a real geological harvest that will keep investigators busy for years.

DEEP TREMOUR

Some of the most important finds so far announced come from the three-station seismic network set up by the Apollo 12, 14, and 15 astronauts.

This network has recorded one very deep tremor originating 500 miles below the lunar surface, which is equal to or greater than the deepest known earthquake. But despite this and other monthly quakes that convulse the interior, and might, on a planet like earth like earth, fracture the surface, there is no visible effect on the moon.

So thick and rigid is the lunar shell that the extent and depth of lunar seismic activity-induced by tidal pull when the moon and earth are closest each month has been completely disguised until now.

The 8½-ft. core sample for example contains 57 separate layers of soil that between them illustrated 2,400 million years of lunar history. The layers range from half-an-inch to five inches thick and each probably represents a different meteorite impact which deposited a new

an acid electrolyte. The acid absorbs moisture from the air, and when electric current is passed through it, the water in the acid solution is broken down into its component parts. Oxygen is liberated on one side of the cell, hydrogen on the other, and a membrane prevents them from mixing.

On space missions the oxygen would be put back into the cabin airstream for breathing, and the hydrogen used for spacecraft systems or jettisoned into space.

LEARNING TO LIVE IN A CELESTIAL BODY

AMERICA TO LAUNCH WORLD'S SECOND MANNED SPACE-STATION IN 1972

The first orbiting science workshop-SKYLAB-is due to be launched in 1972 (this year). The station itself-the third stage of a Saturn rocket and auxiliary equipment for the mission is largely drawn from the proven hardware of the earlier American manned missions. The astronauts who will man the workshop and the engineers who will prepare it for launching have a lot of advance work to do.

They are busy at the Marshall Space Flight Centre at Huntsville in Alabama-where the giant Saturn moon rocket was developed-training and testing equipment on several full scale models.

Skylab is scheduled to take off unmanned-from Cape Kennedy, Florida and settle in orbit 330 miles out. The next day a crew of three will rocket up to join it and live inside for 28 days.

Then they will re-enter the command module, cut loose from the lab and return home via splash-down in the Atlantic. Altogether the workshop is to orbit for 8 months, during which time it will be utilised for three missions. The first will test the crew's physiological and psychological reactions; the second will concen-

trate on examining the sun through a unique telescope on board; during the third, data useful to the earth sciences will be collected. Many experiments will aim at learning how the solar system influences man's environment on earth.

The astronauts will live in a space home in which every facility and procedure has been endlessly tested and revised. The two-level workshop section, three times the size of an Apollo command, ship, includes areas for working, preparing food, resting, waste management and exercise. With temperature, ventilation and pressure systems duplicating conditions on earth, life-support suits will be unnecessary. Enough water and breathing gases (nitrogen and oxygen) to last eight months will be carried, plus a 140-day supply of food-more than enough for the total time the astronauts will stay.

The men will work about 10 hours a day and after the evening meal may relax with games and books or prepare for the next day's research. The most important experiment the first team of three will conduct is just existing, for longer than have any human beings, in the weightlessness and alien environment of outer space. Their reactions will help determine more precisely human capabilities for extended exploration of the solar system.


THE NORTH WEALED AIR DISPLAY-By Sean Boynton.

LEUKAEMIA ? A CURE? A SERIOUS SUGGESTION.

Sometime ago, in a booklet entitled HERE'S HEALTH issued at various Health shops throughout Britain, appeared an article written by Barbera Cartland of a genuine cure at least, for one person, of leukaemia. Unfortunately, the book is temporarily 'lost'. The story however, was of a woman, who was given, I believe, a few months to live by her M.D. Taking the notion that BEE TROOT was reputed to in ancient times, akin to human blood, she "dosed" herself with several pounds (of this we are not sure) of the BEE TROOT per day. She returned to her MD a few months later who on checking her blood count-found no trace of Leukamia in her at all. WE ASK. Does BEE TROOT work on ALL cases, or was this lady just one of those rare cases in history? When I locate the book, the full detailed story will be published.

A M E R I C A AND R U S S I A TO EXCHANGE D A T A ON MARS

The United States and the Soviet Union have agreed to exchange information sent back to earth by their spacecraft. This follows negotiations by joint Soviet-American Working groups of Space-Experts. America launched Mariner 9 on May 30th 1971 and Russia's Mars 2 and 3 were launched on May 19 and 28. A Teletype communications link has been set up between the Mariner control centre at Pasadena, California and the soviet control centre. Any important items of special interest will be exchanged rapidly via this link. Mariner 9 is USA's first attempt to orbit Mars-it weighs a ton, has two TV cameras to send back 5,000 pictures (which will map off more than 70% of the planets surface) and 3 sensors to measure surface temperatures, composition and topography, as well as the makeup of the thin Martian atmosphere. The pictures to be taken over a period of three months, beginning with a series of 54 during the approach phase. Already a clearly defined photo of PHOBOS has been taken out of the intended 12 shots to be taken of Mars two moons -Phobos and Deimos. The other agreement with Russia provides for joint determination of compatible space rendezvous and docking equipment. Footnote: PHOBOS is the moon which is reminiscent of man-made satellites due to its speed of orbit around Mars.

RUSSIAN INFORMATION ON THE PLANET MARS From NOVOSTI INFORMATION

Space-Drive has received no less to date over 18 reports from the soviet Information Service in London on the Mars probes. It would fill the whole of the magazine. Therefore we reproduce the headlines and some details: NOVEMBER 24th 1971 STEREO EXPERIMENT WITH MARS-3

French Equipment is successfully functioning aboard Mars-3 station. Equipment to study the structure of the sun's radio emission.

OBSERVATIONS OF MARS November 29 1971. The appearance of violet clouds on Mars early in August was a great surprize to astronomers. Such clouds usually appear on the morning and evening edges of the disc in the form of light formations. They are best seen in violet rays (from which they derive their name) STUDY OF MARS FROM SATELLITE December 1, 1971

An artificial satellite around Mars may provide a great deal of data about the planet without touching its surface, it can help to reveal the laws and physics of diverse phenomena taking place around Mars.

SOVIET SCIENTISTS DISCUSS MARS. Dec, 2, 1971. Exploration of Mars could answer the question about the origin of life. If living substance is found on Mars, this would give an opportunity for comparison, analysis and generalisation. Scientists would be able to substantiate theories about the spread of life through the universe and about the possibilities of finding it. The scientist Prof Vasily Moroz said that it is possible that conditions on Mars were very different recently. DECEMBER 3

AUTOMOMOUS SYSTEM OF ASTRO-NAVIGATION ON MARS-2. December 6, 1971

SEARCH FOR LIFE ON MARS: In its commentary on Mars-2 and Mars -3

PRAVDA (Truth-Ed.), writes that the search for living systems on MARS is a task of tremendous significance for science in general. The study of yet unknown organisms, if they are discovered, will make it possible to understand the regularities of the development of life in the solar system. Life forms on other planets may have worked out radically new biological metabolisms, regulation and other mechanisms in the process of evolution. Of no lessa significance for science will also be strict proof of the absence of life on Mars. This fact will open up in future possibilities for carrying out biological experiments in the conditions of a fully sterile planet. There may be vestiges of living organisms which existed on the planet long ago, but they can also be of abio-

genetic origin--formed under the influence of ultra-violet radiation from atmospheric gases and minerals in the surface layer of the planet. And, lastly, certain kinds of organic compounds found on the surface of Mars could indicate the existence of the simplest organisms on the planet. Experimentation in solving these problems becomes possible only with the use of specially equipped automatic probes. And Mars-2 and 3 are blazing the trail for them, Pravda says. SIMULATION OF MARS' POLAR CAPS December 6, 1971. Simulating in special chambers the heat and baric regime of Mars, Ildar Zakirov, has obtained a solid-gas-hydrate compound of water and carbon dioxide unknown on earth. Soviet scientists believe represents the most probable solid phase of the Martian polar caps. DEC. 6th 71 Mars-3 Explores sun! SOFT LANDING ON MARS Dec 7. 1971:-

A descent craft of the Mars-3 automatic station softlanded on the surface of the planet Mars on December 2. It parachuted down and landed in the southern hemisphere of Mars between Electris and Phaetonis regions in an area 45°S and 158° W. Installed on the craft was a pennant with the coat of arms of the Soviet Union. Mars-3 continued its flight along a trajectory which passes at a minimum distance of 1,500 kilometers from the surface of the planet. ITS RETROACTIVE ENGINE HELPED SWITCH THE STATION INTO THE ORBIT OF AN ARTIFICIAL SATELLITE OF MARS WITH A PERIOD OF REVOLUTION OF ABOUT 32 DAYS (editor's note: Of the 32 moons in our solar system-PHOBOS, one of Mars' moons, is the ONLY ONE moving around its planet faster than the rotation of its parent body-PHOBOS makes one orbit of Mars in 11 HOURS-like an ARTIFICIAL satellite.) Headlining is ours-Ed. DECEMBER 8 1971 Soviet -U.S. Discussions on Co-operation in space (docking systems etc). THE SOVIET MARS EXPLORATION TO BE CONTINUED.

Every now and then scientists speculate that advanced civilisations may be trying to send messages to earth from outer space. The latest group to support this idea is a distinguished gathering of American and Soviet scientists who met at the Byurakan Astrophysical Observatory in Armenia in September, USSR.

They concluded (1) a few immense technological civilisations in the nearer regions of the Milky Way may be trying to communicate with earth; (2) that by scanning the sky with powerful radiotelescopes we may be capable of establishing contact with such civilisations.; (3) and that on a modest scale, internationally-coordinated efforts should be mounted to try to tune in to messages from outer space. With our present state of technology, the best approach would be to listen rather

Two American delegates, astronomers Carl Sagen and Frank Drake of Cornell University, reported on the findings to the US National Academy of Science, co-sponsor of the conference with its Russian counterpart. Dr. Sagen said that although there was no hard scientific evidence to the existence of intelligent creatures on planets surrounding other stars and through the few efforts (by the Soviet Union, and the USA and Britain) to tune into messages from space had turned up nothing a carefully-structured rationale based on hard scientific fact suggests that there are civilisations vastly beyond our technological expertise. Dr. Drake speculated that advanced civilisations would be sending benevolent messages. Any super civilisation would have to consider economics, and would find a radio signal, what only costs a dollar cheaper than a spacecraft.

MAKING LIFE SEEM LONGER.....

A peculiar and exasperating psychological aspect of the relativity of time is not to be found in any textbook of physics. We are all subject to it. For example: For as we grow older, time goes faster. That is definite. Agreement is universal. We have all been young. We all remember that, as children, the length of time between Labour Day and Christmas was a vast temporal desert nearly four months long. Each day was long, each week an eternity. Now, at maturity, we peer in perplexity at the passing time and mutter, "where did it all go?" Christmas follows about a week after Labour Day, and the years come and go just about the way the months used to a couple of decades ago. It's not really surprising. We measure time in our minds and consciousness, not in absolute terms but in connection with those experiences we have already had. To a ten-year-old, a year is 10 per cent of a lifetime; to a 50 year old, only 2 per cent of a lifetime. Again the consciousness of passing time is largely a memory of novelties. In a period when nothing much happens, nothing much is remembered and it runs together. To a ten-year-old, almost everything is new; each day is filled with exciting events that stand out in memory and intensify the feeling that a "long time" has passed. To a 50-year-old, very little is new; the peaks are lower and fewer, so the time melts together and runs unnoticed through our minds.

The cure? Well, you can't make yourself younger, but you can force yourself to take more of an interest. Learn to enjoy the separate moments of life and to search for what excitement and novelty you can find or make. You may not live longer, but it will seem longer. And that's almost as good.

APOLLO 16 TIME LINE: 73 hrs on the Moon..... (Science Horizons)

The Apollo 16 astronauts will spend 73 hours on the moon in March six hours longer than the Apollo 15 explorers. They will rest for 16 hours before take-off from the moon in order to avoid fatigue. David Scott and Jim Irwin had only 3½ hours between their final moon walk and lift-off. And the picture shows they will have a really flexible spacesuit (not published here this time-Ed.) According to the preliminary time table Apollo 16, with astronauts John Young, Charles Drake, and Tom Mattingley aboard will be launched from Cape Kennedy at 18.03 GMT on Friday March 17, 1972 and will go into orbit round the moon three days later at 22.10 on Monday March 20. Young and Drake, will separate the lunar module on Tuesday March 21, to land in a mountainous area north of the crater Descartes at 22.25. They will make three surface trips in a lunar rover of seven hours each, the first on March 21.3 hours and 53 mins. after landing. The second will start only Wednesday and Third on Thursday. Lift-off from the moon is planned for 23.23 on Friday March 24. Rendezvous with command module is 2 hours later.

The three astronauts will then orbit the moon for three more days mapping the lunar surface with instruments similar to those used in Apollo 15. They will head back to earth on Monday, March 27 and the next day Astronaut Mattingley will walk in space to retrieve film from the mapping cameras in the service module. Splashdown in the Pacific is due at 21.14 Wednesday, March 29th after a mission lasting 12 days 8 hrs., 11 minutes.

FIND A CURE FOR CANCER SOON - CONTINUED

...as bits and pieces of information already at hand are fitted together I wish I knew how to catalyse and speed up this whole complicated interdigitation process.

In that area of Cancer research where I have spent my life-the search for drugs and methods for their employment to eradicate certain types of widely disseminated cancer cells in Animals-recently there has been some exciting progress, although I do not mean to imply that "the cure" for all cancer is right around the corner or that this approach is the only approach to control of disseminated cancer. Perhaps a brief description of the problems and progress in this area of cancer research may give the reader some feel for the complexity of the total cancer problem and the depression and elation (over small and unexpected gains) that research scientists feel from time to time.

With the proper choice of drugs (usually combinations) and treatment schedules, we now can cure a few types of transplanted animal cancers even after they become widely disseminated; however, we still fail with many other animal neoplasms. The stepwise and now almost annual improvement in drug control of some of the widely disseminated human leukaemias and lymphomata, choriocarcinoma in woman, and a few solid tumors in children has been most encouraging.

Hoever, I think we would all like to know why we succeed when we succeed and why we fail when we fail, because from such knowledge we should be able to attempt a rational-and thus more efficient and rapid-extention of our limited successes to tougher and tougher a animal and human cancer.

SOME EXPERIMENTS

I can best contribute to the readers understanding of certain current working concepts about cancer chemotherapy by relating some simple experiments on a single type of cancer: a transplantable leukaemia in the laboratory mouse. (Incidentally, my associates and I work on a variety of cancer in mice, rats, and hamsters, not because we are unduly attached to these rodents, but because what is discovered about their cancer is so often pertinent to human cancer.) In some respects, this mouse leukaemia behaves much like human leukaemia, but, as I shall point out later, it differs in at least one very important respect. At this moment I think this difference may represent one of the major stumbling blocks to the cure of much disseminated cancer.

First, if one takes a drop of blood from a leukaemic mouse (which may contain 100,000 leukaemia cells) and, with the aid of a fancy piece of equipment called a micromanipulator, picks out a single leukaemia cell and carefully injects "into a healthy mouse, two things will happen. First, that single cell will divide and form two leukaemia cells; these two will divide and form four, and then the four will become eight, the eight 16, the 16 32, etc until the number reaches about one billion, at which time the animal dies with leukaemia cells in essentially every tissue and organ of the body. Second, it will have taken about 15 days for that single leukaemia cell and its progeny to proliferate to one billion (an American billion equals one thousand million.) The lethal number of leukaemia cells for man is closer to one trillion. (A trillion equals a million million).





SKYWATCHING

LOOKING FOR UFOS
ON AN ALL-NIGHT
WATCH. The Editor.

Skywatching, to me, was at first something out of the ordinary in 1967 and it was an interesting experience. The all night watch is of course the best, as far as I am concerned as some Unexplained phenomena sometimes occurs at night. I have been on at least 3 such events since that date. On all occasions was the event organised by CONTACT UK in conjunction with the British Unidentified Flying Object Association (BUFORA). One of the best organised, most publicised watches was the one held by CONTACT under the name of International Sky Scouts UK around 1967. The other watch was at Crew's Hill, Enfield, England. We published some of the events of these skywatches in the last issue, however it was not conclusive and much records of the events are lost. So digging into my archives I came up with the following old photos and information about the Warminster watch of 1967 reproduced here from Interplanetary News June 1967:

UFOS: Flying Saucers, Flashing Lights in the sky, the Bible and its teachings about the years of many earthquakes, spiritualism, Tornados, Advanced electronics...this goes on forever, but in some way they all fit together. Today the I.S.T.R (1960) are going to continue their investigation into the Flying Saucer Mystery. So let us start by saying something about the story published in the SUNDAY MIRROR on September 25th 1966 (this was the Barney Hill space kidnap case). David Prockter MISTR member has read this story and has branded it all a hoax. He said that hypnotism is a powerful thing and anyone could have planted a post-hypnotic suggestion into Barney Hill and his wife. Therefore further probing of his mind by hypnotism would only bring out the story already implanted there in the first place. I must say, that in this point I must agree with him, because I have heard of a case which suggests this possible. The story we are referring to was:- KIDNAPPERS FROM OUTER SPACE.

Interplanetary news NO.15 (in colour) went on to point out other things about UFOs not relevant to this article. The next issues no:17 June 1967 carried the story of the WARMINSTER SKYWATCH under the title FLYING SAUCERS? Do they really exist? ...By investigators E.Harris, T.Jordan, R.Harris, John Cowley. "Continuing our search for the truth we went to WARMINSTER Wiltshire to find out.

A Watch on the Wiltshire, rain soaked sky, was organised by Mr. Keith Palmer of the new investigation U.F.O. group for the U.K. the International Sky Scouts. It was on the morning of Saturday 6th May 1967. Members R.& E Harris and John Cowley and Tom Jordan, set out for CRADLE HILL, where most U.F.O. sightings have been taking place. On reaching our destination we made plans and began to pitch our tents. We met another cameraman on Cradle Hill he was from BBC Southampton. Later, when all was settled, Mr. Keith Palmer I.S.S. Organiser, split us up into two groups. NOTE. There were many people there, around 70-100. One group complete with flashing signal lights, formed on nearby surrounding hills, while others remained on Cradle Hill. All apparently looking for U.F.Os. In the afternoon

the two television teams were doing their best to interview some of those people there who had had sightings. E.Harris told on film of a sighting he had in Stewart Road, Leyton, London, in which his wife Rita and friend David Andrews saw on June 19th 1965, but after hearing a very good explanation that it could have been a meteorite that could have broken up into three pieces and glowed red as they burnt out seemed fair enough, but now the search must still go on.

The possibility of interference from outside our own world, of course, must be given serious consideration, we just cannot be THE ONLY EXISTING PLANET IN THE ENTIRE VASTNESS OF OUTER SPACE TO HARBOUR LIFE.

But no matter how hard we try to find proof of these matters, it is still open to skepticism. PROOF! Echoes Jimmy Goddard's Saucer Forum magazine, is that ALL important word that is doing us no good.

However, Arthur Shuttlewood feature writer of the WARMINSTER JOURNAL, told E. Harris and others that he had found PROOF!

E. Harris, almost believed him, especially when he showed him the pictures he had taken of UFOs. These same photos were shown on 24 HOURS programme the following Tuesday. What did sound fantastic was that Arthur said he had phone calls from space people. Photos are generally acceptable as some vague kind of materialistic evidence, but phone calls from aliens from space are another matter. Mr. Shuttlewood told E. Harris also that he had shown his 'PROOF' to Arthur Smith the Daily Mirror Science reporter but what he had to say about this I am yet still waiting to hear. So the "Daily Mirror Chappie" as Arthur calls him should be giving us his verdict.

All the goings on at Warminster as told by Mr. Shuttlewood were somewhat like the following and if Arthur reads this and spots any mistakes, let me know, and they will be corrected:- Mr. Shuttlewood said, that, he had been reading the small advertisements in his newspaper when he spotted an ad' relating to a farmer who had threatened to shoot any DOG that was found worrying his sheep.

Thinking this was a very odd advertisement, Mr. Shuttlewood went to see the farmer. He found that after a few months, the sheep and cattle were in fact, not being worried by any kind of dog, but by A HIGH PITCHED NOISE, not audible to human ears. The army camp in Warminster, have of course, denied that this was due to them. It is so high pitched that it can only be heard by animals.

Shortly after this, Mr. Shuttlewood goes on to say, that, in the evenings and on some nights, red lights have appeared, hovering over fields or bouncing over fields. Instructions have been left with the army in Warminster, according to Mr. Shuttlewood, that should any alien spacecraft get into trouble and crash, they are to get the craft at all costs. Whether this is a true story or hearsay, is another matter.

It all leads us up to a word.. ARE we all going MAD!?

Arthur has written a book on the U.F.Os in Warminster. However, Mr. Keith Palmer of the I.S.S. (now CONTACT) said, that things have now quietened down in Warminster, and there will be no more SKY WATCHES at present at least in WARMINSTER.

DID WE SEE ANYTHING?

E.Harris was asked this question many times.

ANSWER.NO! "All I saw" I replied "was RAIN,SHEEP,COWS,and lots of thick MUD."

However they (his wife RITA) took a stroll in the night, right down Cradle Hill, and on the way back they were met by Keith Palmer, who informed them drastically from the window of a car he had come down in, that he had seen something behind us in the darkness and was going to investigate. What he found he said a few days later, could not be revealed, and (to this day (1971) we still do not know. So wherever he is we would STILL like to know just what WAS behind us in the dark in 1967).

The biggest UFO group is BUFORA, in Britain and they claim to have thousands of sightings in their files.

The International Sky Scouts did however take with them UFO detectors. There is a belief that UFOs fly along invisible magnetic paths termed LEYS. These leys run all over the world and although the expert on them at this time was Mr. Jimmy Goddard, we took the guess of assuming some of the LEYS met in WARMINSTER. One such ley must run from NORTH to SOUTH, and after the UFO sighting in Leyton and a sight-

ing by a man in Leyton who saw a "BUBBLE" sinking into the ground, it seems from this and other administrations that seem to have sprung up in this area that there MUST be a LEY running through Leyton.

The I.S.S originated we believe in Japan. They have members all over the world.

However E.Harris said after the 1967 watch: "The whole Warminster sky watch in my opinion was as interesting as it was a waste of a good weekend" (I had probably said that in 1967 due to the all night soaking we got).

Tom Jordan wrote: "We began the watch but it soon started to rain it kept raining until dawn. Then we went into Warminster from Cradle Hill and got a train back home to London approximately 4.00 pm." FROM INTERPLANETARY NEWS June issue number 17. June 1967.

Shortly afterwards, the skywatchers took on as much scientific approach as possible, and were also organised by the I.S.S to hold a fairly local watch. Therefore the next skywatch was at Enfield on 23rd June 1967.....PTO

At this time I got curious about the actual groups that delved into this "insane" subject, and at that time I began to investigate THEM! Of course being a member of the ISS I wondered more about them than the so called fictitious UFOs they were supposed to find on Skywatches. Not surprising I took this attitude after the Warminster skywatch. Unfortunately for me I produced a leaflet that read: "PHENOMENA" Flying Saucers DO THEY REALLY EXIST? Is there any PROOF? etc etc. Looking at this leaflet today, and at the contents I am not surprised that the wording was sheer rubbish! I am not surprised that I was personally grabbed hold of and hustled off the scene before a surprised BBC man could get hold of one. The objective of the leaflet appeared to throw an accusing question mark at the whole Idea of UFOs and an even greater one at the groups.

I have since that date read up on the subject and realised that there are UFOs but they are very temptingly out of reach of us-like the carrot in front of the donkey.

The magazine PHENOMENA did appear but inside Interplanetary News but more in support of UFOs and the groups. I believe it to be a very good thing to be highly sceptical of an irksome subject, and find your ideas have no ground when the truth finally dawns on oneself.

So the next skywatch at Crew's Hill Enfield went on somewhat like this:-

A BBC SPOKESMAN interviewed Keith Palmer :

BBC: What chances are there of seeing a UFO locally?

KEITH: One can never say-it's fifty fifty, but there have been a few sightings in the north London area the last one was seen in Walthamstow on a Sunday evening.

BBC: Why in North London?

Keith: They are beginning to follow a pattern, which works up and

down in straight lines called LEY lines and now and then every month these objects follow a pattern around every individual town along these ley lines, and I think North London is in for it now for the next couple of weeks..then they'll probably leave there and go elsewhere. BBC: Now the whole world is looking for evidence that these things exist I take it you believe that they exist...

Keith: Yes I do..

BBC: How many have you seen?

Keith: I have seen about a dozen since 1954.

BBC: What do they look like?

Keith: The majority I've seen just look like satellites, going at terrific speeds across the sky-zig-zagging, darting backwards and forwards....

BBC: Is there any real evidence you can produce?

Keith: No! Not any real evidence I'm afraid..

BBC: Where do these things come from?

Keith: They're extraterrestrial they come from other planets as far as I'm concerned, this is just a personal point of view. Other people say other dimensions and so on.. I think they could come from Venus or Mars or other star systems even.

After War of the Worlds, a radio play had finished the BBC returned the Crews Hill Enfield to the skywatchers:

BBC: 40,000 people in 23 countries were out peering into the night sky in a world wide flying Saucer hunt. Well, Barry Brown joined the 40 or so members of the English contingent at Crews Hill, Enfield at the North of London.

Barry Brown BBC: Well, it's rather misty here tonight on the top of Crews Hill but some of the 60 odd skywatchers are optimistic and have their cameras propped up on tripods just in case a flying saucer passes this way, Others are wandering

around with torches trying to find better advantage points. But at least its a different way of spending a saturday night. But one sky-watcher has given up and is playing his guitar. The less energetic are sitting in cars, some intend to spend the whole night here. That is why there is one caravan, two Dormobiles and one tent. The person who spent six months organising this flying saucer sighting day is Keith Palmer. Well Keith what are the chances of someone seeing a flying saucer here tonight?

Keith: Well, one can never say, one can never tell about that, but there has been some sightings not far from here in Essex..quite a few actually some cigar shaped things and disks.

BBC: Why do you believe in Flying Saucers yourself?

Keith: I have seen objects on several occasions some in Warminster, some in London.

BBC: Is London a very popular place for Flying Saucers ?

Keith: I think it is going to be.

BBC: Why do you think its this part of the world?

Keith: Its not just this part of the world but every part of the world there's a sighting every day in some part of the world.

The BBC then took their recording apparatus over to the Dormobile of Dr. Doel, one of the leading figures in the ISS movement.

BBC: Dr. Doel, you are a radiologist by profession, and you have the most comfortable setup here tonight, Where do these unidentified flying objects or Flying Saucers come from?

Dr. Doel: Every year, people look more and more into the universe and see the possibility of other races existing in the universe,


BBC: So you think these Flying Saucers are manned?

Dr. Doel: (with a chuckle) Well they may not be manned or womaned but they have intelligent entities, no doubt, operating them maybe some are remote

controlled-we don't know? We certainly have one or two very authenticated sightings..

BBC: Could you give me an example?

Dr. Doel: The particular one I am thinking of in Papua, a few years ago at a small mission station called Bonei (note cannot find this place on the atlas or the spelling-editor) and one evening a disk shaped craft became stationary in the air not far from the mission station and the astonishing thing about it all, the next night the same craft appeared again, and on this occasion, men, they looked like men down to the waist we could not see below the rim around the top of the craft, waved to them when they waved ..and this is more or less the first authenticated instance in which some communication has taken place between possible people from outside our own planet.

The BBC continued:

Well, Doctor, its now after midnight and there is still no signs of any sightings here at Crews Hill. Arn't

your hopes a little dashed?
Dr. Doel: Not at all! The night is yet young, and as you see I have my camera and other apparatus cocked at the back of my vehicle here just in case we get a close shot.
BBC THE STUDIO: Well as far as I can tell that was the only thing that appeared from outer space that night..we end the programme with strains from Dr. Who.....then on the next day break June 24th 1967 TOWN AND AROUND (television) team, after an all night skywatch prepared to interview...

BBC TELEVISION: Good evening. A little team was searching for unidentified Flying Objects this weekend and reports are now on their way to a study group at Cambridge University. But the sky provided little more interest than the occasional thunderstorm, but for others with cricks in their necks it was uncharted territory when the unexpected might happen at any time. Michael Sullivan joined some of them ..

MICHAEL SULLIVAN BBC: Seven O'clock on a Sunday morning. If any unidentified flying objects from outer space had been anywhere near Enfield during the night, I can vouch for the fact that they wouldn't have passed undetected, because here in this field and neighbouring districts, 60 odd people all well experienced in the business of looking for unidentified flying objects have been waiting for them. They have been reporting their findings to a control room in Paddington. With me here is Keith Palmer, the skywatch organiser- well, Mr. Palmer you have been talking to control quite recently, what have they to say?

Keith: There have been several sightings up and down the country, some in America, and so on.

Keith Palmer went on to describe the organising of the skywatch. And with this programme the Enfield all night skywatch came to an end.

Several skywatches have of course taken place since 1967 but they seem to be less and less elaborate with less and less coverage. Shortly too, the International Sky Scouts changed their name to Contact. In a communique from one of the leading organisations members Mr. Brinsley Le Poer Trench he had this to say:
"Contact is stabilising and progressing steadily, and overseas membership is now some 10,000 overall which makes Contact the biggest movement in the world."

Mr. Trench was the editor of the Flying Saucer Review from 1956-59. Since then he has written five books on UFOs. During the ISS period Mr. Trench was the International Chairman in 1967. At that time Johan Quanjer was National Chairman of Contact (U.K) and the name was changed due to confusion with the Boy Scout movement who do have Air Scouts.

I too was at the Enfield Skywatch and I put two cheap cameras together to form a Stereo unit. Reproduced are some of the photos but in flat. Perhaps I may publish stereo photos in this zine soon.

Skywatching today, for some reason not fully understood, is not very popular. They are held, but not on the grand scale you have just read about. Each year around June, which is the eve of the event 25 or so years ago, they are held with the dedicated getting together. The Condon report had not helped much too. Reports in recently from America and Canada suggests all reports of UFOs in the press are just not being published. This is not so for the local press however. They continue to publish reports.

The next skywatch I have personally dealt with was one held just last year on Saturday 26th June 1971. It was organised by Lincoln Richford and groups who took part in England were:- COS-MOS (Cos-Mos has now amalgamated with SIRIUS), BUFORA, SIRIUS, SIGAP, BUFOS, DIGAP, ISTRG, SIUFOP, CUFOSS, and SPACE-DRIVE. Reports from the all night watch were collated and found their way into the London GUARDIAN a national leading newspaper. The Article, from which we have taken an extract reads:-
SPIRITS AND THE SKY-by Christopher Ford..on a UFO HUNT.

"Roughly 150 people, at 16 sites around Britain, gazed into the often cloudy heavens on Saturday night and through into Sunday morning. Reported sightings during the annual national skywatch of the British Unidentified Flying Object Research Association. amounted to one orange light,

which was probably a helicopter, at Dunmow, the expected crop of satellites, which made for some folk the highlights of an astronomical occasion, a few meteors, and four rabbits. "I don't know how they got in," said the skywatch organiser, Lincoln Richford at 11 o'clock yesterday morning. "I'm a bit slow, I'm a bit tired." He spent his night at a central reporting point in London. They received about 35 calls. The "event" of the weekend was outside the skywatch - described as a bright light in the sky near Sheffield early on Saturday afternoon, stationary for 14 minutes until approached by something like a smoke-ring, and unexplained so far by the RAF. Yet the watch was a success of sorts: "We got the rousps out, they phoned in, we got the practise."

The oddest thing about the ufologists on Pewley Downs, just outside Guildford, was their evenness. They were indeed rather pointedly orthodox people often with a scientific bent: a man in plastics who used to be a pilot, an aircraft engineer, an antique dealer who was once in the Indian Army, a police cadet, a short-haired undergraduate, a local paper journalist, a man in computers - in sum a slightly conservative group, and not necessarily with a small "c". They were there to watch for UFOs, but also to get used to natural phenomena and to develop the teamwork needed in the event of a "flap", which is UFO language for an outburst of inexplicable activity. "Chris Ford went on to relate a skywatch experiment when some rockets were let off ten-miles away and were seen through binoculars. So shop-brought fireworks were not the explanation." They'll try fiercer rockets next year." he adds. (may be continued in the next issue)

The last skywatch of 1971
CONCLUSION. (hope you are still with us readers)?

The lead up to this watch could well have began with a sighting by Mr. Philip Colins 45, a sugar Warehouse foreman of the British Sugar Corporation in Felsted, Essex. He said he was driving past Shotley Essex, when he saw an object moving very rapidly across the sky. It was red and left behind it a vapour

trail which disappeared as soon as it left the object. Mr. Colins who is interested in music said that he didn't know what it was. We have no further details of this unless Mr. Colins would like to elaborate further.- Editor.

The last skywatch of 1971 was kindly made known to me by my friends at the Sugar Corporation which took the form of a newspaper article from the SUN: CLOUD OVER THE GREAT UFO HUNT. Monday November 29th 1971.

Martians did not land on a desolate Warwickshire hillside at the weekend. Such a pity. There was a great welcome waiting for them. The world's biggest hunt for Unidentified Flying Objects was underway on the hill near Banbury. Three hundred Ufologists spent a night with their eyes skyward. But they did not even spot a star between them. It rained continuously Visibility was down to 45 yards. The event had been organised by the International UFO research Association.

Members turned up with binoculars, telescopes, cameras, tape recorders, and devices said to be able to track moving objects in the sky. But as they left Burton Dassett at dawn most of them were still undeterred. They were convinced that beings from other planets had fixed the clouds so that they could not be spied on. Another group of space enthusiasts met at Chelsea Town Hall, in West London.

"Interplanetary medium" Dr. George King from Shropshire, went into a trance and named a flying saucer captain. He passed on a message beginning "We of another planet..." There was also news of the speed at which UFOs travel. Afterwards many followers went for a drink at a Kings Road pub...called The Man in The Moon.

CREDIT: THE SUN November 29 1971 That same afternoon the London television station ITV screened

the event with UFO personalities in the studio on TEA BREAK.

On the programme to discuss the sky watch was Brinsley Le Poer Trench and a spokesman from the Aetherius Society. Also on the programme was Peter Fairly science reporter.

The transcript that follows is not conclusive owing to the late turning on of the TV set....from TEA BREAK:

" must have some concrete knowledge of unidentified flying objects.

PETER FAIRLEY: I don't think anyone has any concrete knowledge. What worries me in this whole business is that it is very hard to distinguish between what is fact and what is imagination. Now, if you take this model for instance (Peter indicates the metal Flying Saucer made by the Aetherius Society-the Adamski type scout craft), Now, if this thing did come from some other planet, and all scientific evidence suggested that it couldn't come from our solar system, then it would have to be very very clever to get that far from other civilisations if they did exist, then you would have expected it to have some means of power to come distances and hover. Well, this thing frankly, isn't big enough to come very far through space because you would need the sun's energy to drive it, unless the other civilisation happen to find some.....

A.Soc: It could well be a scaled down model?

Peter: It could well be a scaled down model, but why shape it so beautifully like something we would expect to see on earth? The other thing is, when you get red lights for instance, reports of red lights, Now, anything that came from another civilisation, why should they have RED lights? The best light to show through space would be a BLUE light! And you would expect a clever civilisation who managed to hover and get this close would be that clever to show BLUE light. Of course RED light is an earthly danger signal, so there is much more chance that these objects have an earthly origin.

Someone in the programme was then asked if he agreed with Peter Fairly.

" Yes, but I would like to comment on the first part of this programme . I think the reason why these models all look identical is because they all look like saucepan lids, and I think that quite a lot of the flying saucer pictures have been made by very elegant people, who throw a saucpan lid into the air and photograph it!

Mr. X: But people have confessed to that.

"Yes I know, but the point is, you then subject that photograph to analysis and of course it isn't a fake, it is in fact a flying saucepan lid. But stop scoffing for a moment. I think that sort of thing does a great disservice to the investigation of the whole phenomenon. Suppose you write off 95% of the reporting due to gullible people in search of a new myth, now that's very important because we haven't got any more myths. Then we come to 5% of sightings which I think are interesting. You get a simultaneous sighting and a radar sighting of the visual sighting.

Then there are airline pilots-they have seen something, no doubt what ever it was it was something. Airline pilots are a hard bitten breed...

Peter Fairley: There are about 20 or 30 well known objects that could be causing this phenomena ranging from escaped meteorological balloons, to the large balloon satellite Echom, to other satellites, to decaying debris, to the refraction of glass on the windscreen of your car, the light of Mars and Jupiter, and venus which are exceptionally bright in the night sky. to the moon shining on cloud formations, and giving an errie sideways glow, -all sorts of things including looking out of a plane window to rivets on

part of the tailplane, suddenly become magnified because of the glass and appear as cigar shaped objects with portholes travelling beside you."

In the studio was a science fiction writer who discussed the fact that science fiction over the years had in fact become FACT!

Coming back to TEABREAK Peter Fairley had this to say about UFOs:

PETER: The annual total of all these sightings and tries to investigate each one, something like 11-12,000 have been reported, good reports, and of these something over 600 have not yet been explained, and probably cannot be explained, there is certainly such a thing as an unidentified flying object, the question is whether it is a flying saucer or whether it is coming from somewhere else in the universe, or whether it is something close to earth which we cannot yet explain. My feeling is it is probably the latter. I listened to a paper being read by a serious scientist, proposing a robot flight to inspect(27)

Alpha Centauri which is the nearest star from us and that proposed a journey of $17\frac{1}{2}$ years, to get there. So if they can think serious now of looking at other civilisations or looking for other civilisations in other parts, then, then I accept that other stars may have the power to do it to us.

That I am beginning to get a bit worried about, is that it is over twenty years now since these things started getting sighted and none of them as far as I'm concerned has yet landed.

KEITH: I disagree that it's only the past 20 years. As far as our research goes and that of others, these craft go right back into antiquity. You have only got to pick up a book on the Christian Bible.....

"Not just the Bible but all the ancient texts describe the Gods that came from the heavens.

After much table talk about where to find a myth and also that different eras had their own kind of myth when people were under pressure etc., Peter Fairley went on to explain that some people whenever they see a report for the first time will then start looking up instead of at the ground and see all kinds of natural phenomena they have never seen before like Venus, Jupiter etc., and take photos of them for the first time.

After outlining a sketch of a fiery cross and what a spacecraft could possibly look like from it, they asked Brinsley Le Poer Trench if he thought that this could have been the fiery cross of 1968. Brinsley L.P. Trench: It could be a drawing of one, an illustration yes! What I would say is, it is quite remarkable that when

your people are looking up at the sky they do see something. Now, the interesting thing is, that this is not just housewives, but very often Police officers...Ufos in 1967, down in Devon, and after that a whole lot of other Police officers started seeing them up there in the Midlands. Now the other day we had this interesting sighting in Aldrige in Staffordshire, Answering Brinsley (someone): "But with all this we still don't know of any explanation. We still don't know whether they are from our own planet, or people chucking saucers up, or an escaped balloon, OR whether they come from outer space?"

Mr. X : There is NO evidence about unidentified flying objects, very little evidence-hearsay reports, one or two films, that could be done in hundreds of ways, from a good special effects man, I don't deny at all the possibility exists, until we have the evidence to examine, the thing must remain in the realms..."
.. "You claim that you have GOT evidence?"

Aetherius Soc (?) Well, all I can say here is we have got cuttings, depicting hundred of sightings from the beginning of this year, just over this country alone.

The TV debate from those gathered at the skywatch mentioned earlier continued, and is far too complex for this (short) article on skywatching here. However the programme and the skywatches for 1971 came to their conclusion:

CONTACT WITH ALIENS by CONTACT Group from Brinsley Trench as he was asked:

"Could I ask you one question? If there ARE things coming down from outer space can you tell me what is in them, are there people in them?"

BRINSLEY: People have been seen in some of them, now for instance, ..

BBC?: "You don't mean little green things!???"

Brinsley: NO! But there have been several good reliable witness sightings Atlantic, Trinidad, Islands, but another one I have in mind is the

New Guinea, Papua. There had been a wave of sightings over that area Papua, 1958...

BBC: Could I ask you what they looked like?

Brinsley: People on the ground, peered over a mission, and the Reverend Gill, in charge of the mission, was witnessed by his assistant and some mission boys...

BBC: And did they look like people?


Brinsley: ..and they saw 4 or 5 people in this UFO, who were said actually to, -a-because, because the people on the ground were waving, AND.....(programme fade out to intense background music).

Therefore with the SKYWATCHES for 1971 concluded, and with the TV debate we end this marathon article on the subject. Please note the following message from MR. Trench on his comments after the programme that he kindly sent to me on request for more information: (4th December 1971)
"Dear Edward, Many thanks for your letter of 29th November and for your kind remarks about my TV appearance. Actually, I was very ill at ease on the programme. I was drawn into it at the last moment. As it was an unrehearsed programme I do not recall what else I told the interviewer and anyway, as I did not see the finished programme on TV I do not know at what point my talk about the New Guinea near landing was cut off by the conclusion of the programme." Brinsley Le Poer Trench.
Editors note: Well Mr. Trench, now you have read this marathon report you know exactly where it ended. Besides, Dr. Doel had told us some detail earlier. If Stephen Smith of BUFORA read this, I would like to ask for any more information on this NEW GUINEA landing. Many thanks if you can help.

In France on 26 July 1967 at 8.05 p.m., the film 'Malican pere et fils' was being shown on the television. BIG BANG? STEADY STATE-OR PULSATION. By Arthur Shuttlewood

Continued from previous issues.. "It stems from a number of factors:

1. The consciousness must have a 'physical' body to sustain it; 2. that consciousness is at one Universal level of 'seeing' and "hearing" etc., as we ourselves do; 3, that technological achievements are required in order to cross the abyss of space, i.e. 'they' use 'craft'.

4, That only a superior intelligence to man could achieve this level of technology; 5, that the intelligences are motivated by the same needs as Man. i.e. they may be friendly or hostile, or both at the same time, therefore the element of doubt and fear enters their calculations. 6, That the physical body of their consciousness cannot be very different from ours, hence stories of entities from eighteen inches up to nine feet are plausible; 7, therefore, craft cannot be very different in size or design from craft we use, i.e. five feet up to thousands of feet. 8, The faculties or senses imposed certain design features- for example, portholes TO SEE THROUGH, aeriels for radio reception TO HEAR, ladders and lifts TO WALK DOWN, i.e. 'they have bipedal locomotion and stand erect like man. All this assumes that consciousness, intellect and will are the exclusive properties of Man, with his clear physical affinities to primates on earth. The implication is that there is a convergent evolution of carbon-based life systems TOWARDS the goal of consciousness and that this is on an interplanetary or intergalactic basis. One has only to look at all the life forms on earth to realise that evolution is predominantly divergent and that the problem of survival is solved in diverse ways.

So it must be elsewhere... Another point: We always speak of ourselves as the most highly evolved creatures on earth, or even the Universe. This can be shown to be false. If you are a dog, for example, you think as a dog and act as a dog; and you can comprehend and to some extent assert control over all other animals whose level of intelligence is LOWER than your own. Thus dogs believe their little canine world to be populated by all the animals of lesser intelligence. Of those whose intelligences are greater than theirs, they have no comprehension in the ANIMAL sense. Hence, to a dog, Man is probably a God- a benign influence in the life of a dog, provider of shelter and food, but quite incomprehensible. Are we not in the same vision-restricting position? Are we not vaguely aware of other Higher Forces at work which we are pleased to call esoteric, arcane or even occult? Are not the most highly evolved humans we can think of in touch with these forces to the highest degree? (The most intelligent dog is, after all, a good friend to his master). 
When did you see the object?

KIM: 17th April 1971

Time? KIM: 9 pm.

Where were you when you saw the object? KIM: Dane O'Coys, Bishop's Stortford, Herts.

Kim said the object was in sight for about 5 minutes, and it was cloudy. There were no stars, and the object appeared as a light but brighter than the brightest star. The object was fuzzy and seemed to explode after changing brightness and flashing. During the sighting the object disappeared behind some trees. There was no sound and the colour. A match stick held at arms length would not cover the object.

She said that the speed of the object was around 10.MPH. she was standing approximately 500 yards from it in open countryside. It appeared at an elevation of 45° and disappeared at elevation of 15°. There was more than one object. There were 2. With Kim were 4 witnesses: Helen Gatland of the Dane Park, Graham Stevens of Dane Acres, Gary Hagger, Kevin Johns of Slivers.

Kim a bright 12 year old reported the sighting to Mrs Sargent of Dane Acres.

As footnote, Kim said it was definitely NOT an aircraft.
