

BLACK HOLES IN SPACE ARE STRONG ENOUGH TO SWALLOW SUNS


Discoveries of dark areas of space have proved to be collapsed suns which instead of exploding are imploding inwards giving out strong gravitational waves. It has been suggested that if any matter from such a region were possible on earth it would weigh tons per ounce. (an almost unbelievable aspect).

The apparent black hole is Cygnus x-1 a source of X rays, weak radio signals are coming from it. They are thought to contain as much as half of all the matter in the universe, was reported at a meeting of the high-energy astrophysics division of the American Astronomical Society at Caltech. Black holes occur when a large star burns up all its hydrogen and collapses in an "implosion" pulling all its matter in with it. The matter becomes enormously heavy and the gravitational field becomes so great that it will not allow the emission of any light, thus, becoming invisible. Light orbits around the black hole and any light coming near it is swallowed up. This absence of any light creates a problem for astronomers - how to look for a black hole. They believe the best way to look for a black hole is to examine binary systems - in which two objects orbit around a common centre. By examining the orbit of one visible star, scientists can tell the mass of the other invisible object. If the object emits X rays it could be a black hole. "It is almost inescapable that Cygnus X-1 is a black hole," Dr. Ricardo Giacconi, astrophysicist of the American Science and Engineering Laboratory, Boston, told more than 200 scientists attending the meeting. "It should be provided that a blue super giant star that is near it actually is linked with it as part of a binary system." Cygnus X-1 as a black hole was made from data gathered by the Uhuru satellite, which is orbiting the earth with an x-ray telescope. CREDIT THE TIMES (New York Times??) By R. Are Flying Saucers being built in Cologne??




FROM THE MOON-TO WHERE? From AWAKE! Nov.1969

"The moon is only the first milestone on the road to the stars..the doors of heaven are now opening." So stated British author Arthur C.Clark about man's first voyage to the moon. A headline in the New York Times declared "Johnson says Feat Shows 'We can do Anything.'"The paper added "To former President Lydon B.Johnson, the successful landing on the moon means that America 'can do anything that need to be done.'" Thus, after the astronauts moon walk many may say, in effect: 'If science can reach the moon there is nothing that it cannot accomplish.The whole universe now belongs to man.' Man's walk on the moon is an amazing technological achievement. Yet, there are erious questions that must now be asked: Is man really "on the road to the stars"? The Apollo saturn rocket was 363 feet tall and 33ft wide, weight:3,200 tons and was made up of more than fifteen million parts! Man's going to the moon is practically nowhere! This can be seen when we consider the next target for a manned space voyage--MARS. The United States government recommended the nation's space goals for the 1970s said:"The moon is in our backyard..but anything else is going to be 100 times farther. The next step to a planet is so huge in terms of energy and time that it represents an enormous problem of human endurance ingenuity, navigation and communications..You have such an enormous gap between the moon and Mars that Mars is just not imaginable." Estimates of the time it would take for a voyage to that planet vary. Some say a mission to land men on Mars would take about three years-a year to get there, a year to touch down on the planet and search for life and a year to get back to earth. World book encyclopedia states:A trip to Mars and back could take about 17 months. However with a more powerful rocket, one estimate is that the round trip could be made in about 400 days. It has also been suggested that stations could be established on one planet after another until the outermost planet of our solar system was reached. If going to Mars involves such awesome complexities, imagine what it would take for a manned spaceship to reach Pluto. Yet even these problems pale into insignificance when we consider what it would take to go beyond our solar system "to the stars."

Does Carol believe in life on other worlds? "Yes! It's the only logical answer after all we would be very egotistical if we believed that out of an entire universe, planet Earth was the only one with intelligent life and I also believe the flying saucers, or at least some of them are controlled by beings from another planet." After Carol's visit she headed back to Canada promising to come again some day. Topside ceased when Darrel Watkins became ill.



ANNOUNCEMENT TO CNK READERS:

 CNK shall continue.



A QUESTION ON EVERYONES MIND...HOW DO U.F.Os WORK?

Here may be some of the answers:- By the editor

People today THINK TERRESTRIAL, their thought patterns boarder along the lines of motor car engines using oil and electrical systems, and along lines of rocket propulsion and all EARTHLY man made inventions of this century. If a person wants to travel the immediate thing that comes into their mind is EVERYDAY transport. To find out how EXTRATERRESTRIAL things work, we must THINK along lines of inventions that have NOT YET been invented. There is an abundance of natural forces all around us that are to be used providing we can find out just what machinery is to be constructed to harness these forces. Some of the machinery will be OUT of concept of todays configurations. I am writing this article because I have been tinkering around with anti-gravity research and some of the unusual lines of approach I have been working on the final drawings and models that ensued staggered me to find that if these things COULD be put into practice they would resemble the flying saucer BECAUSE the mechanics of the internal structure WOULD have to be Saucer shaped in order to work. Some of the designs for an anti-gravity motor I have worked on, if when a shell be placed round it would become either CIGAR, SAUCER, or EGG shaped. The performance of such a machine would RESEMBLE the performance of UFOs in the skies. The speed may be either slower or just the same as the UFOs. I have been working for two months on these new age conceptions and so far I have nothing to show for it. Newtons third Law of motion kills some of the anti-gravity effect, while in theory it puts it into orbit. The basic problem seems to be power. UFOs probably have a step down internal atomic motor to give high revs to the mechanical device needed to use the natural forces around them. This may well be why the colour changes. Mercury, and aluminium play a great part in UFO construction, maybe so does nylon and electromagnetic motors and magnets needed to turn the same type of motor I envisage. To actually tell the reader just what my ideas are would not be practical in case they prove to be negative, in which case its back to the drawing board.


