

WHOSE MOON IS IT ANYWAY?

An exploration by Nick Nicholson

Just when I felt it was time to relax, along comes this Mark chappy and says

"Where's your contribution to the next issue?"

"Pardon?"

"By Saturday" he replies.

"OK".

"Oh, about the moon".

Vanishing, he leaves me to it.

Fortunately the subject is fresh in my mind. Even so, it is difficult to know where to start. There is just so much information on our nearest neighbour. First off, agreement has not been reached regarding its origin. It was not once part of the Earth that broke away. Earth's gravity did not capture the moo, if that was the case it would occupy an equatorial orbit which it does not. A concept put forward by a Russian scientist is that it was steered into orbit millennia ago. A vast space ark!!

Speculation about the moon being hollow or at least having voids inside have long been discussed. This theory was given credence by experiments carried out during the Apollo missions. After seismographs were placed on the moon a redundant empty booster shell was slammed into it. The result was the moon ringing like a bell for up to four hours. The echo only showed a depth of 22-25 kilometres. It has always been rumoured that NASA carried out additional tests to determine the


extent of the spaces in the moon's interior. The Apollo astronauts commented on activity seen on the moon's surface, even described light activity on crater rims!!

In the early seventies many of NASA's photographs were available to the public and George Leonard, author of "Someone Else Is On Our Moon", began looking closely at the evidence. Some veiled and noncommittal comments were all he got from officials, until a former mission specialist agreed to talk to him. He views the moon in a new light and finds a wealth of information. Structures larger than anything on Earth. Huge machines performing mining on a global scale. How is it that all this is ignored? The answer being professional astronomers love for deep space. The lure of the moon is not enough, at best it's an annoyance, at worst, it's a light polluting monstrosity!!

In 1843 Schroeter recorded a crater naming it Linne, six miles across. Over the years he watched it fade until now it seems just like a small pit. The observations of lights, dust, shadows and structures have been recorded often enough to fill volumes.

On one image from NASA an object is seen to leave a trail across the lunar surface. Even better is that the object is still visible and has ROLLED UP out of a crater. Hard to explain unless it was motorised!

If all this interest wasn't enough for NASA to contend with Richard Hoagland is now exploring the moon. His evidence has been publicly discredited as nothing more than tricks of the light. Extensive imaging of the Sinus Medii region showed him exactly where to start his search. Getting his hands on a rare lunar atlas (by unusual means) his first breakthrough came in the first week. Within the floor of the crater Ukert was the tetrahedral symbol of the Mars Cydonia region. Other anomalies sprung up everywhere.



THE SHARD

A rough battered spire over a mile and a half tall, located on the south west perimeter of Sinus Medii. Enhancement reveals a highly reflective crystalline structure. Fine vertical lines may indicate that it is supported by a separate structure. During the enhancement of the shard another object seemed to be above the horizon. After examining the camera data it soon became apparent that it would not have caught a distant comet or gas cloud in space. After high definition processing this smudge became a cube some seven miles high above the lunar surface, possibly sitting upon a tower!

THE CASTLE & DOMES

Further examination of frames show more and more oddities. One, called 'THE CASTLE'

because of its similarity to "Schloss Neuschwanstein" sits 10 miles above the moon. Comments that the structure looks like frosted glass are not uncommon. Near Mare Crisium stands another spire, quite straight and reaching 20 miles to the sky. Believed to be anchored in a crystalline dome it seems to reflect on another dome near the crater Picard.

Apollo 15 astronaut, Al Worden had this to say about the area :-

"It is very strange the way the ejecta from

Proclus crosses Crisium. It is almost like flying above a haze layer and looking down through the haze. It looks like it is suspended over it".

Information from a Soviet unmanned mission revealed that the area displayed unexplained high levels of reflected light and 3-5 times the levels of ultra-violet light.

The Moon still sits there full of surprises just itching to be found, while we abandon '**The giant leap for mankind**'.

We have reached for the stars and seemed to have turned back

THE RED PLANET STARES BACK

An exploration by Nick Nicholson

The images that we have from Mars come from the 17 year old Viking spacecraft. Prior to the first images in 1964 from Mariner we had a Lowellian picture of Mars. Seasonal changes seen as a darkening on the planet indicated seasons of some sort. The 'canals' of Mars had been reported but was losing favour with most astronomers as they couldn't find them at all. Still the idea of some form of life beckoned. When the first signals from Mariner 4 were received it shattered all those ideas. At a range of 6000 miles and with poor image quality the cratered, barren surface was revealed.

More Mariners followed, the last, number 9 transmitted 7329 images. The resolution was between 100-300 metres and 1-3 kilometres. The new pictures stunned all. Huge volcanoes, the biggest in the solar system - a rift valley which makes the Grand Canyon look like a scratch.

It was some time later, after the 60,000 pictures relayed back to earth were examined that something extraordinary was found. There, on the martian landscape was something that had all the attributes of a human face. Extremely large, it could just not be ignored. NASA did!!! The official view, even today, is that it is nothing more than a trick of the light.

The face was just the first of many anomalies that were later found by Richard Hoagland and

team members of The Mars Mission. The members are scientists, engineers and interested parties. I fall into the latter category. NASA has taken it upon itself to publicly denigrate Richard Hoagland and The Mars Mission because of the new data which has been revealed. The geometry surrounding the area has been called tetrahedral geometry is also associated with crop circles. The relationship has been applied to Wiltshire, in particular the Avebury/Silbury Hill area. The subtle links of a cosmic jigsaw are beginning to come together.

Next we come to the ill-fated Mars Observer. Its imaging system was to be the best. Mapping as much of Mars as possible. Richard Hoagland campaigned for the Cydonia region to be rephotographed stating to NASA that it was their chance to shut him up for good. Shortly before Mars orbit was to be achieved, Richard Hoagland and Dr Bevan French (NASA's program scientist) appeared on a breakfast TV show. Dr French's lack of composure prompted the remark 'acting like a cobra in a mongoose pen'. French was unable to satisfy Richard Hoagland or the presenter who posed the question

"Take the pictures and shut these guys up"!!

At 11.00 am that very morning NASA announces that it has lost contact with the Mars Observer, some 14 hours earlier. Rumour has it that the Mars Observer is alive and well and photographed some stunning things. **Who do you believe????**

STAFFORDSHIRE UFO & CROP CIRCLE INVESTIGATION & DISCUSSION GROUP

So, what's been happening at this group over the past few meetings. The last meeting featured Graham Allen giving an informative presentation on local UFO activity. Having followed the local sightings in depth his talk opened up many locals eyes when they realised just how much activity was on their own doorstep. Showing triangular sightings and their link with the Belgium wave he showed that, contrary to public belief, the triangles have been around for much longer than usually thought.

The Meeting before had Nick Nicholson present his ideas of the Face of Mars and the activity that surrounds the Moon (see the two previous features in this issue). His talk was supplemented by a video presentation created by himself.

Thanks to a dedicated band the first of what is hoped to be many skywatches has taken place. Meeting on a Saturday at midday and running until 8.00 a.m on the Sunday morning it showed a level of dedication quite unheard of. Even rain for much of the night failed to dampen spirits and much enjoyment was had by all. Tents were erected so people could retire for a while before joining the motley crew outside. The highlights of the entire affair were a 'CSETI-like meditation' guided by myself which produced a good feeling around the group. Although nothing was seen plenty was felt and other skywatches will take place. Future events include crop watches and a crop circle prediction competition. The East Midlands CCCS will join in this one and who knows what will happen.

Close Encounters of the fifth kind

The CE-5 Initiative Principles of CSETI

Definition : CE-5 is a term describing a fifth category of close encounters with Extraterrestrial Intelligence (ETI), characterised by mutual, bilateral communication rather than unilateral contact. The CE-5 Initiative has as its central focus bilateral ETI-human communication based on mutual respect and universal principles of exchange and contact. CE types 1-4 are essentially passive, reactive and ETI initiated; CE-5 is distinguished from these by conscious, voluntary and proactive human-initiated or cooperative contacts with ETI. Evidence exists indicating that CE-5's have successfully occurred in the past, and the inevitable maturing of the human/ETI relationship requires greater research and out-reach effort into this possibility. While ultimate control of such contact and exchange will (and probably should) remain with the technologically more advanced intelligent life forms (i.e. ETI), this does not lessen the importance of conscientious, voluntary human initiatives, contact and follow-up to conventional CE's type 1-4.

Core Principles and Premises of the CE-5 Initiative

1. ETI and Extraterrestrial Transports (UFOs) have been and currently are in contact with human society.
2. ETI has a net peaceful, benign and probably protective motive for the relationship with humanity at this time.
3. The CE-5 Initiative is proactive, bilaterally communicative and multi-disciplinary in nature and is not primarily motivated towards the current acquisition of ETI technology, except as mutually permitted by the ETI-Human relationship.
4. ETI's enigmatic and elusive behaviour may be understood as human-protective when viewed from their perspective; a war-torn, aggressive, nuclear armed and disunified Earth civilisation must not receive further potentially harmful technologies until a lasting world peace and unity is achieved, and international human goals become peaceful, cooperative and unified in nature. Such

a transformation will then indicate the readiness for a fuller contact and exchange between humans and ETI. We must respect and accept ETI's control and wisdom in this regard.

5. Notwithstanding the protective limits mentioned above, ETI is apparently desirous of an expanded contact with humans, and is open to voluntary, human-initiated contact and exchange. There is strong evidence to suggest that ETI has been systematically introducing themselves to human civilisation for the past 45 years or longer, and that such contact has steadily deepened and intensified over this period.
6. CE-5 communication based in a paradigm of love, unity, nonviolence, cooperation and shared interests has been and will continue to be most effective.
7. In addition to point number 4 above, we may expect a certain limited nature to ETI contact so that the disruptive potential of such contact will be minimised. Certainly, a massive influx of ETI culture, technology, etc., would prove harmful to long-term human evolution if said influx was sudden or ill-timed. Though the exact limits of such contact are not known, we are probably destined to experience an expansion of these limits as human civilisation evolves and grows in peace and unity, or at times of significant world-wide crisis.
8. All CE-5 Initiative contact will be for the benefit of all humanity (as well as ETI) and will not redound to the benefit of only one nation or culture. This is essential.
9. All CE-5 Initiative contacts will be free of hostile intent, and will be free of the presence of any and all weaponry, defensive or offensive.
10. All CE-5 Initiative contacts will be shared with all CE-5 Associates to the extent possible. The CE-5 Initiative will cooperate with all other UFO/ETI research organisations so long as such groups are credible and have nonharmful and peaceful procedures and intentions.

11. Both humans and ETI have physical and mental/spiritual aspects to their reality, and contact and communication will proceed on all levels of our shared reality.
12. The CE-5 Initiative affirms that humans and ETI, as conscious beings, are essentially more alike than dissimilar. Regardless of how different we may externally or physically appear, the reality of humans as conscious and intelligent beings establishes the common basis for communication, deeper and bilateral contact, and mutual self-respect.
13. Our embryonic efforts now will have ramifications throughout the next millennium and should therefore be undertaken with all due deliberation, vision and integrity. Our goals, methodology and conduct are oriented towards a broad-based, long-term endeavour.
14. The primary model for communication and exchange, as well as internal communication within the CE-5 Initiative, is that of consultation and respect for the views of others.
15. The most important characteristics of CE-5 Initiative participants are honesty, open-mindedness, intuitive ability, good communication skills and trustworthiness. Technical skills and academic credentials are certainly valued, but the above qualities are primary. CE-3 and CE-4 contactees are especially encouraged to participate as research associates. Participant confidentiality will be assured if requested. In addition, CE-5 Initiative Core Groups will ideally have participants expert or competent in:
 - a. Medicine/Physiology
 - b. Physics, Theoretical and Applied
 - c. Psychology/Counselling
 - d. Higher mental/spiritual functions (e.g. meditation, telepathy)
 - e. Communications and Electronics
 - f. Public Relations
 - g. Research/Documentation, including video, audio and print
 - h. Astronomy and Astrophysics
 - i. Sociology and Anthropology

16. CE-5 Initiative Core Groups will work with ongoing research efforts to maximise our collective knowledge and database. Current and ongoing CE-1 to CE-4 sites/locales or individuals will especially be integrated into CE-5 strategic planning.
17. CE-5 Initiative projects, training and results will be shared through conferences, symposia and publications.
18. The activities of the CE-5 Initiative will maintain high standards of conduct and professionalism, while preserving an atmosphere of open-mindedness and creative "brain-storming". Anyone found to be spreading misinformation of falsified cases intentionally will be prohibited from participating in any of the activities of the CE-5 Initiative.
19. We hold that carefully planned Close Encounters of the Fifth Kind will unlock new frontiers in the relationship between ETI and humanity. All sincere researchers and theorists are welcome to join in this profound endeavour on behalf of mankind's growth and evolution.



EARTHLIGHTS & THE WILTSHIRE UFOs

One man is always associated with the Earth-lights theory, Paul Devereux. The link between tectonic activity strongly suggests that some UFOs are the by product of natural energy which is released by the Earth. Stresses created by moving land masses are enough to trigger earthquakes and so maybe they can release an energy which we can observe in the visible spectrum.

Experiments have taken place that show if certain rocks are brought under extreme pressure complex light emissions are generated. The exact nature of why this should be so are unknown. Suggestions that these 'lightforms' may have electrical fields associated with them which may affect the brain are made all the time. To most UFO investigators this is no problem. There should be no danger of every UFO report being explained by a 'lightform' creating electrical interference in the brain. However, some 'investigators' have seen this as a way of dismissing the UFO phenomenon. Dr. Susan Blackmore continually puts forwards her ideas that UFOs are a product of a hallucinatory mind. Unfortunately she loses her credibility almost immediately by ascribing every sighting to this effect. Something which anyone with a discerning mind will see straight away as nonsense.


Nonsense notwithstanding we still have these enigmatic balls of light. Some balls of light are far stranger than just 'lightforms'. They seem to show intelligence and react to events around them.

The place is Wiltshire, the end of July 1995.

The witness, none other than your editor and two others who joined me on Knapp Hill, overlooking the infamous 'Eastfield' - home of the 'Led Zeppelin crop circle album cover'. Skywatches take place here all the time and it's a great place to be out in the open. I have my binoculars and still camera with me mounted on a tripod with a 400 ASA film inside. In the early hours of the morning, about 3.00 a.m., three balls of light are observed by us all. We watch them for some minutes being reacting to their presence. Being a member of CSETI, my first thought is to act calmly and send positive thoughts to the three orange balls of light which make an equilateral triangle in the sky. These are not flares, we may be on the edge of Salisbury plain but they shine steady and long. They are not aircraft, they don't move. Helicopters? No chance, not with how bright they are. After some moments I inform the two others that I will try and photograph them. Turning my camera towards them and look through the lens. There they are. I press the shutter release and the autofocus lens system whirrs into action. Instantly the lights wink off together, not to be seen for the remainder of the night!! The work of Earthlights? I think not. Intelligent? I think so. Conventional aircraft? Again I think not!!

Lights which seem to react to the presence of cameras and individuals are seen all the time. Reports of 'I turned my camera to it and it winked out' or 'It shot away when I tried to look at it thought my binoculars' are not uncommon. Thoughts also create reactions by many of these 'balls of light'. 'I asked for it to come closer and no sooner had I said it when it shot towards me'. 'I asked for it to do

something unusual and it suddenly changed direction'.




The Eastfield Eye from 1994

Other sightings which took place in Wiltshire include the unusual flashes of light which come from the sky. Reported in New Scientist magazine they have always been associated with clouds and thunderstorm activity. No such luck in Wiltshire. Clear skies and a silence accompany these flashes. Seen in other parts of the country it is quite a strange sight. Seemingly an electric blue in colour (if seen from a good, pollution free site) they light up the entire sky.

A sighting which was reported quite extensively by the media happened this year. According to sources it was a meteor. All the astronomical journals say so and being a member of the British Astronomical Association I am kept up to date on happenings. When this was seen in Wiltshire little did we know that it was seen all over the country. From Scotland to southern England the reports were very similar. When I came back to Mansfield and received reports from here the problems first began to appear. From Wiltshire I saw the object travel from the north to the south-east. This was all agreed upon by those who witnessed it. My eyes are used to picking out small details among the stars and I observed the object as an irregular shaped ball

which seemed pink/red in colour. As it shot over the sky it left an emerald green sparkling trail. The trail fizzled like stars and left a glow when the object winked out. In Mansfield the description tallied almost exactly. One 'error' became apparent. It was travelling from south to north.

For some time I received conflicting reports on the direction of travel of this object. It's easy to explain it away as a meteor. One thing's for sure, those who saw it will never forget it.

Wiltshire has always been a hot spot for UFO sightings. Maybe it is the ancient sites such as Silbury Hill and Avebury. Maybe more people are out looking for them in Wiltshire. This is certainly true in the summer. Maybe it's no coincidence that crop circles occur mainly in the Wiltshire area, although in recent years they have moved to Sussex and Hampshire.

You can rest assured that during the end of July there will be a resurgence of interest in Wiltshire and the circles. The UFO Enquirer will be there to take it all in and will present a special issue in September covering the sightings and the circles.
