

SURE FLYING DISCS REAL--Ottawa, Canada, 7/6/57--If mankind put on a crash program such as led to the atomic bomb, they could have space travel in 10 years, in the opinion of Wilbur B. Smith of the department of transport. But he doesn't think that in 10 years time we will have our own flying disc, for governments apparently aren't interested in pouring out the billions of dollars needed for studying how the flying discs work. How long will it take, Canada's most ardent student of flying discs was asked. He figures if governments hadn't decided on a crash program for atomic energy, it might have taken from 100 to 150 years to get it. If research proceeds in the usual way, and no big league program is put on in regard to the technology of flying discs, it might take from 100 to 150 years for man to get flying discs for the big move into outer space. One barrier to a governmental crash program in this field is that the flood of publicity, "much of it garbage," has made it look ridiculous "and the scientific facts have been ignored so that the public and those who control governmental purse strings have a distorted view of the whole thing." Though his work in the department of transport is divorced from flying discs, he has made a serious effort to discover all he can about these UFO's--unidentified flying objects. He has, as a hobby, checked with many people who have claimed to have seen them. He has concluded there is a 91 percent probability that what they saw was genuine and a 60 percent probability that they were "alien vehicles." To even a veteran science fiction reader like this reporter it comes as something of a shock to talk with a man who, after lengthy study, is so convinced that aliens from outer space have been among us that he chats about them most casually. He was asked if he thought mankind might be shocked into a massive investigation of flying discs by having one appear in public. "UFO's have been with us for the last period of civilization," he said. "Since they have not manifested themselves to us in that way, I do not see any probability of them doing so in the future. They probably see us as a low form of life, interesting to keep an eye on, but they do not care much what we do." He said he is personally convinced that they are "extraterrestrial," out of this world. One idea is that they are "inter-dimensional," able to move from one dimension to another. He believes a study of how they operate would reveal the technique of space travel. The U.S. plan for an earth-girdling satellite, he feels, "is going at it the hard way." About 180 tons of fuel is used in the U.S. plan to put a 20-pound weight into space. He is convinced the secret of space travel can be uncovered by human beings "if they devote time and effort to it." But it would be a big job. Just how big he doesn't know. "Something of the scope of IGY--the International Geophysical Year?" he was asked. IGY is peanuts, he said. He thinks the next great achievement of science will be a break-through of the gravity formula. "Once we can explain gravity, we can do something about it," he observed. "Then we won't have to depend on aerodynamics for lift. We can use gravity as much as it now uses us and we probably will be able to cancel some of its laws." He hastened to add that, if there are flying discs, they do not carry creatures from other planets, but are intelligence-gathering devices launched from other planets. "We would be awfully conceited," he declared, "to think that the Creator who created this little earth and its people did not create other earths and other creatures. And there is the chance that they were created before we were, have perhaps survived periods of self-annihilation such as we now face, and thus are so far advanced in logarithmic education that they are not only curious about this and the other planets in outer space but are able to do something about it. THE SECOND COMING OF NOAH'S FLOOD, from a shift of the axis of the earth, and A NEW THEORY AS TO WHAT UFO'S ARE, by Adam D. Barber. Part One--I am selling a book "The Coming Disaster" covering the discovery I have made that at the end of every 9,000 years (round numbers) the axis of the earth shifts, nearly end for end, causing a great flood similar to Noah's. I believe Noah's flood was caused by such a shift, and not by 40 days of rain. Before giving a synopsis of the book, I will first touch on my theory as to what "UFO's" are and their connection with this soon coming catastrophe, if any. Let me first state that I am deeply grateful to the "UFO" fans for the generous support I have received from them in the form of donations to help the cause along and orders for books, and if it becomes within my power to reward them with positions of service in the rehabilitation of the world, I will certainly do so. I particularly appreciate this opportunity of returning the favor, with information as to the precautions that should be taken for survival through this great flood. Until very recently I myself believed "UFO's" were spacecraft from other planets, and still believe that such is possible, but I do not think it likely. I fully believe in and have had proven to me that "mental telepathy" is a fact, and if the "UFO's" contain intelligent beings, it is possible through mental telepathy to communicate with them. A few weeks ago I made a thorough study of the books on "UFO's", and as a result have arrived at a theory which I have not read of nor heard mentioned. I will describe this theory in some detail, but first I wish to mention that I do so for the sole purpose of assisting the public and particularly "UFO" fans in taking precautions for the flood, and to prevent them from relying on "UFO's" to come and swoop down at the critical moment and carry the good people away to safety. Many have written me that I am the "prophet come to save the world; Lazrus, the brother of Jesus; a savior like a thief in the night; etc., etc., and that as a reward for my efforts in informing the world of this discovery and disaster, the "UFO's" will swoop down and save me, or in some other manner. Although I have passed up opportunities of gaining considerable wealth, on account of interference with my efforts in this program, I do not profess to have any preference at being saved. I will remain here, in Washington, until the world is fully informed of the catastrophe and then I will take to the mountain tops and have a boat there as an additional precaution. Although I have been assured by hundreds of people that the "UFO's" will rescue me, I do not depend on that, and I wish to impress on the world that no one should depend on "UFO's". The source of salvation through the flood is boats, balloons, helicopters, and mountain tops, and I make this statement with every respect for different opinions held by other people, which they are justified in considering the numerous sightings of luminous objects which have been reported. On reading the following explanation of magnetic luminous fields, I believe everyone will consider it the most logical explanation of what "UFO's" are. I have not heard of this theory before and I present it as an entirely new evaluation for the careful consideration of everyone. I believe the "UFO's" are merely luminous electromagnetic fields. This is a term few people are familiar with, except electrical engineers and those engaged in magnetic welding as done in factories, and in the following lines you will read of convincing proof. One book on flying discs unwittingly gave the clue and proof of this theory. An incident is described where two pilots encountered or came close to a luminous object or "UFO" and were forced to bail out over a city on account of the intense heat that suddenly came in the cabin as they passed the "UFO". I attached every credit to this report as certainly pilots would not bail out and desert their plane right over a city unless forced to. A similar incident is also described as to a plane over Okinawa during the war. On landing, the pilots stated they passed a luminous object very closely and that their cabin became so hot they could barely endure it. These luminous objects were magnetic fields and I will now explain how they created the heat in the cockpits of the planes. As before stated, magnetic fields are used in factories for welding metal parts together. An electric coil (cold to the touch of the hand) is set up, with an alternating current. This creates a magnetic field, and whenever a piece of metal comes within the field it melts or becomes hot, to melt almost instantly if the field is of sufficient strength. Strangely, you may place your hand within the field, with no effort whatever on it. This heating is due to the fact that the metal (which is placed in the field) is made up of magnetic atoms or molecules. As the current alternates thousands of times, rubbing against each other and thus causing the heat. In the factory the two pieces of metal to be welded together are placed within the field and within a few moments they are so hot they melt together into one solid piece, although as above stated, the coil causing the magnetic field remains cold, but if one touched it and also a water pipe with the other hand, he would receive an electric shock. This same

process took place when the planes came within the magnetic field of the "UFO". What causes the magnetic field of the "UFO" to be luminous I do not know, as the factory counterpart is not luminous. There could be some kind of a gas, such as neon gas (which becomes luminous when electrified) within the field. This natural creation of magnetic fields is somewhat similar to the accumulation of electric energy in a cloud, causing lightning and thunder. This natural magnetic field should have no difficulty in traveling at great speed and reversing its course suddenly, as it most likely travels in some natural magnetic channel, which can be as irregular as the path of a bolt of lightning. From the foregoing I am convinced that "UFO's" are luminous magnetic fields although it is within the range of possibility that some of them are spacecraft from other planets, occupied by intelligent beings, but I do not think so. I say I merely THINK--I make no positive statement as a fact. The natural tendency of the forces in such a magnetic field is to be equal so it follows that the luminous objects would be round. It is also possible that the gas could at times cause the object to become invisible, as a mirage on a hot day presents the appearance of a lake on the highway, making the highway itself invisible. Angel's hair, supposedly coming from the "UFO's" is nothing new either. At least 47 years ago when we lived on a farm, a considerable quantity of it floated down and I gathered a handful of it, took it to my father and we decided it must have been some kind of moss blown from trees. This angel's hair could be the product of the magnetic field, being created from natural acids and gases in the air. The matter I gathered was the stringy white fibrous substance as is described in the UFO reports. It is my opinion that there is no connection between the "UFO's" or magnetic fields and the current multitude of earthquakes, or flip of the axis. (Next month--The Big Flood).....RECENT REPORTS OF AERIAL PHENOMENA--Seattle, Washington, 7/1/57--An unexplained blast shook South Seattle and parts of the central business district shortly after 5:00 p.m. (Source: Seattle Post Intelligencer).....Half Moon Bay, Australia--7/2/57--The globe wireless relayed a message from a freighter off Australia that reported "unexplainable yellow glowing lights" in the sky. The message, from the Matson Line freighter S.S. Sonoma, was received at the local station about 5:00 a.m. They said the position of the freighter was just north of Sydney, Australia. The ship wired that a check with Australia points indicated that there were no flare exercises in progress in the area at the time. The report said there were about eight of the glowing lights which were traveling away from the ship and then disappeared over the horizon. "It looked like a flaming golf ball, traveling at tremendous speed", Mrs. Frank Wendel, supervisor of the ground observer post at Alamo said. The sighting was made at 8:15 p.m. and the light was visible for at least three minutes. "The light kept blinking but the object made no noise that we could hear". She added that the post, which is set up at her home, is equipped with a highly sensitive listening device which is capable of bringing in the noise of birds in trees blocks away. (Source: Harlingen, Texas, Valley Star).....Warsaw, Indiana--7/8/57--Sixty-five-year-old Reginald W. Berry, well know Warsaw commercial artist and his wife, Marjorie were fascinated and held literally spellbound by an unidentified silver object they saw in the sky near Irish Lake at 7:30 p.m. They were driving along a country road south of the lake when Mrs. Berry, sighting the object in a clear blue sky, asked her husband to stop the car. They both got out of the car and watched the object hovering at an altitude estimated between 5,000 and 6,000 feet. It appeared disc-like in shape, and whitish-silver in color. One side of the object appeared to dip toward them as it hovered overhead. They said they watched the object for about five minutes until another motorist appeared on the scene which contained another couple. The two couples stood by for nearly 15 minutes attempting to identify it. It appeared very large. Its size was estimated at approximately four to five times that of the nations largest commercial airliner. It appeared to slowly move out of sight to the northwest. (Source: Warsaw, Indiana, Times-Union).....Galveston, Texas--7/9/57--Many Galvestonians couldn't believe their eyes when they saw a red and green object come in high over the island from the west, turn slowly and go southwestward into the horizon--in about a 30 minute demonstration. Mrs. A.D. Suderman of 716 Broadway reported she and her neighbor Mrs. Paul Rudat stood on her front porch and watched the object. "It was about 7:15 p.m.," Mrs.

Suderman said. As soon as she spotted the object, she turned strong binoculars on it. It was high in the sky, way above the sunset. I could have drawn a line between the red top and green bottom. There seemed to be a black dot at the front of it. I used a tree branch as a guide and noted it slowed considerably when it turned. As it turned and moved southwest the green disappeared and it was all red, like a large goldfish." (Source: Galveston, Texas, News.).... Norfolk, Virginia, 7/11/57--A visitor to Roland Park reported seeing two "whitish" circular discs flying at a rapid rate through the air at about 6:30 p.m. "They were going faster than a jet," she said. "And I heard no noise, none at all, not even after they had disappeared." She added that the discs had no lights. But in the near-dusk she could see the white discs quite distinctly. Lockport, New York--7/12/57--An Upper Mountain Road housewife reported seeing several twirling lights in the sky about 4:50 a.m. "I saw four or five lights in the sky twirling around. There was a mist behind them; then they separated. I went outside and watched them until 5:00 a.m. The spectator said the lights were distinguishable from the few visible stars, because "they moved, but the stars stood still." "It hung in the sky, then descended slowly, bobbed up and down some more, and then shot upwards at a terrific speed and disappeared," said Mrs. Arthur Galiette. She said she and her husband and their twin ten year old daughters and a neighbor's boy watched the mysterious object for about three minutes. It was 6:55 p.m. when the object was sighted, and the sun was setting. "It was very bright, brighter than the sun," said Mrs. Galiette. "I asked my husband to stop the car so that I could watch it." The mysterious object "bobbed up and down, then dropped down like a spider dropping from its web," the woman reported. "Then it shot up and seemed to disintegrate," she added. Charleston, Ill.--7/16/57--A giant skyquake was felt from Charleston to Indianapolis at 10:00 a.m. (Source: Charleston, Ill., News).... Monterey, Calif.--7/16/57--Two sharp skyquakes were felt in Monterey at 2:20 p.m. (Source: Monterey, Calif., Peninsula Herald).... Terre Haute, Indiana--7/17/57--A sharp skyquake shook this city, knocking plaster board from the ceiling of one home. (Source: San Bernardino, Calif., Sun. Credit: Bill Hegt, A.P.R.G. Correspondent).... Emmaus, Pa.--7/17/57--(The following is the contents of a letter received directly from witnesses). The following is a statement from my 11 year old son in regard to strange flying objects. He and one of his friends saw this at about 8:45 p.m. just as it was starting to get dark. I also saw a strange object the same night...My friend and I were walking home from the fire station when we saw the object. We were just crossing over some railroad tracks when I started to tell\_\_about the first star you see at night...we kept on walking until we were almost one half block from the street. That is when we saw what we thought was a star. When we got to the street we saw another object that looked like the first object. ...Then\_\_yelled "its moving!" We ran to see what it was. At that time it swooped down closer to us. The object was round, it had square windows or portholes, and very, very bright lights. We ran to the back of the house and saw it swoop down very close to the ground, but after that our view was blocked by a tree. That is what we saw. Many people don't believe me including my father because I'm young.... Amarillo, Texas--7/17/57--(The following is the contents of a letter received directly from witnesses). Between 11:30 and 12 Midnight, my husband and I saw strange traveling lights in the sky. It was a clear night and all the stars were showing. These objects looked very much like stars, but had a slightly reddish cast. The first were close enough that we could detect a whirling motion and a faint halo. When we noticed the first object it was to the north of our house. It continued south with an irregular flying motion that could not have belonged to an airplane. It would go along straight, then appear to zig-zag...at times, to reverse its motion for an instant. In the south it stopped and stood still for as long as we watched it...We saw at least seven of the traveling lights...most going from north to south...Two from south to north--east of our house. One would fade in the distance and we would see another. We did see two at the same time. They didn't flash across the sky, but went slowly enough for us to easily keep sight of them.... Auburn, New York--7/18/57--A witness reported seeing a "cigar-shaped" object in the northwestern sky shortly before 9:00 p.m. Gazing at the object through a telescope, it appeared to change colors, from red to green. (Source: Auburn, New York, Citizen-Advertiser).... San Francisco, Calif.--7/22/57--A giant skyquake hit this city at 11:02 a.m. causing large buildings to sway and knocked dozens of people to the ground. (Source: Seattle, Wash., Post Intelligencer)

Lake Tahoe, Calif.--7/22/57--Two girls, 12-year-old Karen Zunino and 14 year old Judy Banks, both of Millbrae, San Mateo County, Calif., were standing near the boat landing at the trout fishing harbor near Stateline on the south shore of Lake Tahoe when something that "looked like a ball of fire suddenly zoomed down at the twosome. Harold Rauch, operator of the boat rental, stated that he saw the ball of fire knock the girls down. The girls were unconscious for five minutes, but the attending doctors reported no injuries. (Credit: Bill Hegt, A.P.R.G. Correspondent).....Creston, Iowa--7/23/57--Four boys, two of them members of the Ground Observer Corps said they saw a UFO. They watched the object, which they described as a ball of whitish-orange light, at three different times. The boys were camping out, when they saw the object the first time about 11:15 p.m. The boys said the object they saw appeared similar to one which the Canadian Ground Observer Corps has been tracking for the last month. The Canadian report from Toronto said the Canadian GOC has orders to keep a close watch on the mysterious object which it has been observing for a month. Herb Harrison, a Canadian GOC Chief Observer, said "It's like a little ball of fire. It keeps shifting from north to east to west to south. We have no idea what it is." (Source: Creston, Iowa, News-Advertiser).....Southern Ohio and Northern Kentucky--7/23/57--A sharp skyquake shook Manchester, West Union, Bethel, Georgetown, and Ripley, Ohio. Also, Fearnleaf, Dover, Minerva, and Maysville, Kentucky. The skyquake hit at 8:00 a.m. (Source: Maysville, Ky., Evg. Pub. Ledger; Covington, Ky., Times-Star; Lexington, Ky., Herald; Maysville, Ky., Independent).....Los Angeles, Calif.--7/25/57--A loud skyquake shook this area at 3:30 p.m. (Credit: Member Mrs. Howard Lyden Taylor).....Amarillo, Texas--7/28/57--(The following is the contents of a letter received directly from a witness) I had just gone to bed when I began looking out of the window. I could see what first looked like a star, but as I continued watching, I could see it moving. Then I could see a smaller object and the two looked like they were fighting each other. The smaller one would come up to the large one and seemed to be hitting it along the edges. The large one was bluish-green in the center and white around the edges. The small one blinked on and off like a white light. I could see flashes of light going between the two objects and the large one began wavering. There was a big flash of light that came out of the large one and the small one disappeared. This all took place between 12:00 and 12:30. Then I started scanning the sky to see if I could see others and there was about ten large ones to the west and nine to thirteen to the southwest. They were all in some sort of formation and standing still. They then joined together in one formation. The smaller formations joined the large one to the west. I quit watching at 1:07 a.m..... Tacoma, Wash.--7/30/57--This area was shaken by a skyquake at 10:00a.m. (Credit: Member Clara Ivins. Source: Tacoma News Tribune)..... Charlestown, South Carolina--7/30/57--A number of the residents of the North Area are convinced they saw a UFO. George Isgett said the object appeared almost directly overhead at about 7:00 p.m. and hung in the sky almost an hour. He said the object appeared to be at a great height and was very small. He called a number of neighbors, including Air Force personnel, who also said they saw the UFO. Mr. Isgett said the Air Force was notified and that later a jet plane was seen climbing toward the object in the sky. The UFO shot away and disappeared to the southeast. The Air Force had no comment. (Source: Charleston, S.C. Post) .....Galt, Ontario, Canada--7/30/57--Fifteen-year-old Jack Stevens, who says his eyes are as good or better than anybody else's, is sure he has seen a spacecraft. And no matter what older people say, Jack is sticking to his story. He lives on a farm a mile outside the city about 50 miles southwest of Toronto. "I'm not sure if it was the noise or the bright light that made me look up," Jack said. "My dog Tex was really barking and yelping. The craft made a queer kind of singing hum. I thought it was a plane at first or even a helicopter." Jack said he was about 300 yards away while the craft hovered over a corn field. "It must have stayed in the air about 40 minutes before landing," he said. "It was about 40 feet in diameter and had a turret and port holes. It was silver colored. When it hit the ground I got scared and ran home. Tex was right behind me." All this took place on July 30th, the boy said. He said nothing when the boy got home. He related: "But the next day I got to wondering about the craft. My eyes are as good as anybody's. I wanted to make sure I wasn't seeing things." So with a friend, Harold Milroy, along to bolster his courage. Jack returned to the scene of the spacecraft landing. There the two found a burned circle and two three-toed prints in a corn stubble field. "If it's a hoax, I don't know how it could be done," said G.S. Knapp, owner of the farm. He pointed to six or eight patches which appeared to have been burned. "If they were caused by a field fire, the whole area would have been destroyed," he said. The so-called footprints are 10 inches wide

at the toes, about 18 inches long and taper to a point at the rear. Newsmen at the scene said the marks must have been made by a heavy object in order to force down the corn stubble two inches into the ground. After making his find, Jack still said nothing until August 3rd when he went to the local newspaper office. Police and Royal Canadian Air Force Officers made no comment. "I guess we have to look at it this way," said one farmer with a smile. "Until proven otherwise, it just might have been a spacecraft." "I only wish Tex could talk," Jack said as he petted his dog. "He also must have seen it." (Source: Detroit, Michigan, News).....Bernville, Pa.--7/30/57--Farmer Edward Groff reported he was standing in one of his fields at night when he heard a strange whistling sound. Suddenly a 50-pound piece of ice plummeted down and buried itself in the ground. Groff rushed to his home and told his wife what had happened. The two went outside to examine the ice cake. As they approached the spot there was another whistling sound and a second piece of ice--this one about half as large--landed at their feet. Groff took the two pieces of ice and put them in his freezer, then called state police. An investigation turned up no answers to the puzzle of why a pair of ice cakes should drop out of the sky. A spokesman for an airline said the ice cakes couldn't have come from an airliner because the largest bits of ice carried by such craft is of cube size. Their 12-year-old son, Dean, told newsmen: "I just was taking a walk in the yard when I first saw it coming over the mountain from the southwest. I first thought it was an airplane with flashing bright lights but then as it got closer it didn't look like one. Then it suddenly came in and hit the ground with a thud about 20 feet away from me. Flames shot up and lit up everything around." The object was described as about the size and shape of a baseball and weighing about two pounds. (Credit: Member Frank Kehm. Source: Allentown, Pa., Morning Call).....Fresno, Calif.--8/13/57--(The following is the contents of a letter received directly from a witness). Object first sighted coming out of southwest, about 1/6 from the horizon to overhead, at 10:46 p.m. DST. Its shape was clear-round with 3/4 dome, and was about the size of a large cantaloupe, to the naked eye, as it passed close to overhead. It was of a dull aluminum in color, no lights--no noise. Very smooth in flight. Visual sighting 8 seconds and observed with field glasses 16X50 for 3 seconds. Held straight flight path with very little upward shift as it was lost to sight behind trees--traveling southeast direction. Speed, I judge, about 150 mph. Height about 1200 feet. I would swear, under oath, to above sighting.....Salem, Oregon--8/15/57--An unidentified "reddish light" was seen over Salem traveling in a westerly direction. Three men at the KSLM transmitter in West Salem reported sighting the object around 9:30 p.m. They included Dennie Ermel, KSLM announcer; Robert Schwartz, Statesman reporter, and John Harvey. "It couldn't have been an airplane because there wasn't any noise from the engine and it was traveling too fast," Schwartz said. (Credit: Member Lisa Chase.
