TENTH NATIONAL UFO CONFERENCE HELD IN ATLANTA - PHILLY NEXT

The tenth annual National UFO Conference (formerly known as the Congress of Scientific UFologists) was held in Atlanta, Georgia, June 21-24. Participants in the convention included a number of national ufologists, as well as members of the general public and local science fiction fans.

While the moderate delegate turn-out was smaller than in past years, the public session, held at the Lenox Square Auditorium on Friday evening, June 22, 1973, was estimated to be larger than all recent conventions of the National UFO Conference. The public session, which surpassed the attendance at the 1970, 1971 and 1972 conventions, featured nuclear physicist Stanton Friedman, with a preliminary program preceding. The preliminary program included James W. Moseley, chairman of the Permanent Organising Committee of the convention, and Eugene R Steinberg and Curt Sutherly of Caveat Emptor magazine. The audience size was estimated to be over 300, with standing room only available for many after the seating was sold out.

On Saturday afternoon, June 23rd, 1973 I presented Mr. Moseley with the fifth annual Robert Lortin Memorial Award.

Earlier, on Friday, the convention held its business session. Attending were James W. Moseley, Rick R. Hilberg, James Rule, Curt Sutherly, Allen Greenfield, Eugene Steinberg, Geneva Steinberg as the session began at approximately 2:15 PM, coming in later were Gray Barker and Barbara Greenfield. Our speaker, Mr. Friedman, also sat in on part of the session. The following actions were taken: (1) A vote was taken commending John J. Robinson on his work done on the Journal of the National UFO Conference, issue number five. It passed unanimously; (2) Curt Sutherly was appointed to establish contact with Dr. Saunders in connection with a project established the previous year; (3) A Commendation award for past chairman Allan J. Manak was unanimously approved; (4) A bid for the 1974 convention for Philadelphia was unanimously passed; (5) Unanimously approved change in the convention by-laws: "TITLE THREE, Section 12: The Permanent Organising Committee will serve as the convention committee and will have the job of selecting a site and conducting the annual National UFO Conference in the year 1975. The members of the Permanent Organising Committee can select individual members to perform the day-to-day organising and preperation of said convention. This Section repeals Sections nine and ten, Title Threexxfor 1975" (6) Curt Sutherly was appointed to the POC, replacing Mr. Kevin McCray. (7) A vote to rescend ~~xxx~~ debts to previous conventions was passed. (8) A semi-annual meeting was set-up, to be held in Washington, D.C., December 29th and 30th, 1973, at the Holiday Inn on New Hampshire Avenue. Arrangements remained to be made. In addition to these actions, Curt Sutherly gave a presentation dealing with a UFO report and its aftermath. Mr. Rule, who was present at the session, was one of the witnesses.
