

OPEN LETTER TO ALL DIRECTORS OF ALL UFO INVESTIGATIONS ORGANIZATIONS

My Dear Colleagues:

As President and editor-in-chief of an International UFO publication and organization, it is my job to see that the most current UFO events are made readily available to my subscribers and members. I am sure you place yourselves in the same situation.

Through the years I have found it measurably difficult in acquiring this UP-DATED material for publication. The only reason for this is lack of communication between all our respective organizations. The only reason for this communication deficiency is because, as of this writing, no one has come up with a workable solution in getting a "world-wide" UFO observer network off the ground. Therefore, I would like to take on the responsibility of organizing and directing just such a network, with your complete cooperation. Such a network will prove invaluable to all our research and investigations, both now and in the future. It will guarantee up to the minute UFO reports on an international scale.

PROPOSAL

- 1) Network shall be titled "SAUCER COMMITTEE ON PLANETARY EVENTS (S.C.O.P.E.)
- 2) SCOPE shall consist of all, already established, world-wide UFO organizations.

- 3) The Director of each said organization shall act as the SCOPE representative for his organization in the following manner:
 - a) Collect and mail all UFO reports to SCOPE Headquarters on a STRICT weekly basis.
 - b) Encourage all respective members of one's respective organization to send in all photos, newsclippings, etc. on a regular basis to YOUR Headquarters. In turn, YOU should re-mail these articles, etc. to SCOPE H.Q.'s immediately.
- 4) As acting director of SCOPE, it will be my job to see that the following duties are carried out rapidly and efficiently.
 - a) At the end of every week, UFO reports, clippings, photos, etc. shall be compiled according to date, copied (XEROX) and distributed in the SAME week to all representatives of the SCOPE organization.
NOTE: All original reports sent in, once they have been copied, shall be promptly returned to the organization which submitted it.
- 5) Once YOU have received copies of all the weekly UFO reports, you, as Director of your own organization, can now be in a position to offer only the most up-dated UFO material to your subscribers of your own publication .

SCOPE is, at the time of this writing, absolutely a NO-COST, NO OBLIGATION SERVICE. We merely want to present the up to the minute details of UFO sightings around the world. CAPRI will pay the cost of copying and distribution of all material sent in.

NOTE: All organizations must credit original source (organization) of all reports.

I sincerely urge you to act now! Don't be left out in the cold with the same old methods of securing OLD-HAT in-



THE CONDON COMMITTEE DISCLOSURE

No Visitors From Outer Space (?)

After two years of studying UFO reports, a group of top U.S. scientists concluded that "flying saucers" have earthbound causes and do not represent "visitations" from other worlds.

STORY BEHIND THE DECISION One day in 1947 a civilian pilot (Kenneth Arnold) reported seeing a series of disc-like objects in the sky near Mt. Ranier, Washington. The objects, he said, looked like "saucers" and the term "flying saucer" was coined.

The wide publicity accorded the incident was followed by a rash of reported sightings.

In the past 22 years, an average of more than one sighting per day has been reported to the USAF, which was given official responsibility for investigating the UFOs.

As the reported sightings increased, so did the number of people who believed the UFOs came from outer space. Some charged that the Air Force was deliberately concealing information about the phenomena.

Two years ago the Air Force set up a \$500,000.00 investigation of UFOs, to be conducted by a team of University of Colorado scientists, headed by Dr. Edward U. Condon. After two years of study, the Condon Committee has issued a three-

volume, 1,500 page report.

The Committee concludes that UFOs are caused by phenomena on earth and do not come from another planet. UFOs pose no military threat, and there is no reason to conduct further formal studies at this time.

But some true believers were not convinced. One group of flying saucer enthusiasts, NICAP, dismissed the Condon Report as "a waste of money." NICAP charged that the study ignored the "vast majority of reliable, unexplained UFO sighting cases."

Already, James McDonald, a former member of the Condon Committee, has attacked his colleagues by writing a book entitled "UFOs? Yes! Where The Condon Committee Went Wrong."

Many of the most famous UFO cases and photographs were exploded by the Condon team. A fragment of metal purported to be from a flying disc that exploded in mid-air was discovered in Brazil in 1957. Analysis in a Brazilian government laboratory was said to have shown the fragment was made of pure magnesium which could NOT have been PRODUCED ON EARTH. But the Condon Committee sent the fragment to Washington, D.C. for further analysis, and this time the lab tests suggested an earthly origin.

The Condon Reports also explained away many of the flying saucer buffs most prized UFO photos. Most UFOs turn out to be fairly common objects such as weather balloons, flocks of birds, kites, etc.

Nevertheless, despite careful investigation, there remain some (many) unsolved cases. No one could explain a radar "blip" which was detected following a commercial airliner on May 13, 1967. The blip on the radar screen overtook and passed the airliner. No one in the plane, the control tower, or the airliner behind the plane could spot any-

thing. Concludes the Condon Report: "This must remain as one of the most puzzling radar cases on record and no conclusion is possible at this time."

While many UFO believers say this and other cases destroy the validity of the Condon teams report, an eleven member panel of the National Academy of Sciences gave its approval to the report. Researchers stressed the difficulty of applying the scientific method to emotional issues such as UFOs. Since 213 B.C., UFOs have been reported, and it is likely they will continue despite the Condon Study.



The Mysterious Air Force Men

The men who impersonate U.S. Air Force officers are closely linked with the three men in black and are usually put together.

These men are the three men's or the men in black counterparts. It is supposed to be obvious that they are not from the Air Force since they are being hunted by the Air Force for impersonating officers.

These men have put in more appearances than the men in black.

Several Air Force officers silenced some of the witnesses to the Wanaque object.

An American secret agent supposedly visited Gianpietro Monguzzi after he took a series of saucer pictures in the Italian Alps in 1952.

In 1965 a man with NORAD credentials came to Rex Heflin, who had taken a series of UFO photos, and demanded the originals. NORAD naturally denied the incident.

George Adamski in Gray Barker's Book of Adamski tells of his visits: "I have been visited by many agencies, including the F.B.I., Central Intelligence Agency, Air Force Intelligence, the U.S. State Department and people from other government agencies. Now, I am not saying that these peculiar people tried to silence me." If this is true, it appears that the Air Force is not the only government agency interested in UFOs. There is increasing evidence that the CIA, especially, is interested in UFOs.

It is happening throughout the U.S.A. that peddlers and door-to-door salesmen are becoming interested in flying saucers. There are an increasing number of cases where these peddlers and salesmen turn up after a sighting and would rather discuss the sighting with a witness than to sell their

wares. In one case, a salesman selling kitchen utensils came to a witness and discussed the sighting for over two hours without making one sales pitch. These cases were more frequent, percentage wise, in the early 1960's than they are now.

All of the cases mentioned, although some of the persons were "silenced", contained no violence. The credentials took the place of the violence. It is questionable whether the credentials were genuine but they did the job they were meant to do. It is hard to guess how many persons were "silenced" for "the good of your country."

On Dec. 6, 1968 at 6:55 p.m., a private investigator by the name of Tony Edwards, while sitting in his car, observed a disc-shaped object darting across the sky from a northeasterly to southeasterly direction. He described the object as a definite disc shape, hazy white in color, and entirely noiseless. The object appeared to be about half the size of a full moon, he continued. In the final phase of the sighting, the object seemed to pass in front of the moon's relative position in the sky --- BUT it did not re-appear out of the other side. It simply seemed to disappear. Tony finished his statement by adding that weather conditions in the vicinity of observation was entirely cloudless, cold and clear. Duration of the sighting was about 20 seconds.

On the night of Dec. 3, 1968 at about 9:30 p.m., Robert Colon (Local Director of the Gardena, Calif. branch of CAPRI) and his friend, Tim Kozeluh, while walking home from the neighborhood store, were suddenly distracted at the appearance of an odd light in the heavens. The light, which

was seemingly stationary at a very high, uncalculable altitude, changed in color from a dim to a very bright orange. The weather at the time was cool and calm without a cloud in the sky. The duration of the sighting was fast approaching the 15 minute mark when suddenly, as mysteriously as it had appeared, the object simply disappeared out of view. Bob added that the "light" seemed to "shut off" the same as you would switch off a light bulb. There was no sound heard whatsoever.

This report comes from servicemen stationed at Mayport Naval Base. On Nov. 2, 1968 two bright objects approached each other ... one from the northeast and the other from the southwest. Claysburg, Pennsylvania



THE BIZARRE MYSTERY OF M.K. JESSUP AND THE "ALLENDE LETTERS"

This is the allegedly true story of the secret documents that triggered off a full scale Naval investigation

Has the U.S. Navy accomplished the TELEPORTATION of a warship from Philadelphia to its dock near Norfolk, Virginia by the application of Einstein's "UNIFIED FIELD THEORY?" (i.e., Unified Field Theory is an attempted explanation of gravity and electromagnetic force by mathematics) Further, this simply means turning matter into energy waves and broadcasting the object (matter) from one point to another, much the same as a radio, or more like a T.V. with certain variations, of course ... such as the tremendous amount of energy necessary to effect transmission.

The man who might have been able to answer this was the LATE Dr. Morris K. Jessup, who, on April 29, 1959, was found dead in his parked automobile in Dade County Park, Florida ... a victim of apparent suicide due to carbon monoxide asphyxiation. Still, after almost ten years, his colleagues and top UFOlogists insist that it was NOT suicide, but a price that had to be paid by Jessup for coming too close for comfort to the real truth. Jessup had been an instructor in astronomy and mathematics at the University of Michigan and was

awarded his Ph.D. in astrophysics at Drake University.

On January 13, 1956, Jessup received the first of a series of strange letters signed by "Carlos M. Allende" (or as he sometimes signed them, "Carl Allen"). Allende begins his first letter by telling Jessup he should not have demanded research into Einstein's Unified Field Theory. Allende DOES say that the theory had already been used!! The result was complete invisibility of a Navy destroyer and all of its crew. "This incident was supposed to have taken place at sea in October of 1943. Furthermore, half of the officers and crew on board the ship are NOW TOTALLY INSANE!" A few are confined to certain areas where they may receive help when they go blank or get stuck. He also stated that the experimental ship disappeared from its Philadelphia dock and, only minutes later, reappeared at its other dock in Norfolk, Newport News-Portsmouth area, Virginia. The ship then disappeared again and reappeared back in Philadelphia. Allende list personnel on observer ships, the crew of a Matson Line liberty ship out of Norfolk, and he implies that he himself observed the experiment from on board the S.S. Andrew Furnseth. Allende signed this first letter "Very disrespectfully yours."

It was Einstein's letter to President Roosevelt that brought about the Atomic Bomb.

What other SECRET experiments might the military have conducted with Einstein's Unified Field Theory? Think how invincible a fleet of INVISIBLE warships would have been during World War II. Yet, it would not have been any more inconceivable or fantastic than the Atomic Bomb.

FASTER THAN LIGHT

QUESTION: I thought nothing was faster than light, but Feinberg says tachyons move faster than light. What are they and how is it possible?

ANSWER: Einstein's Special Theory of Relativity requires that any object that exists in our universe cannot be made to go at a measured velocity greater than that of light in a vacuum.

But just suppose an object were moving faster than light.

Light travels at 186,282 miles per second, but what if a certain one-pound, one-inch-long, object happened to be travelling at 263,000 miles per second. If we use Einstein's equations, it turns out that the object would then be $-\sqrt{-1}$ pounds in mass and $+\sqrt{-1}$ inches long.

In other words, any object moving faster than light would have to have a mass and a length expressed in what mathematicians call "imaginary numbers." We have no way of visualizing masses or lengths that are expressed in imaginary numbers, so it is easy to assume that such things, being unthinkable, don't exist.

In 1967, however, Gerald Feinberg of Columbia University wondered if it were fair to do that. Perhaps an "imaginary" mass and length is merely a way of describing an object with (let us say) negative gravity - an object that repels matter in our universe instead of being gravitationally attracted

Feinberg called these faster-than-light, imaginary-mass-and-length particles "tachyons" from a Greek word meaning swift. If we grant the existence of these tachyons, can they follow the requirements of Einstein's equations otherwise?

Apparently, they can. Feinberg was able to show that we can picture a whole universe of tachyons going faster than the speed of light yet following the requirements of relati-

vity. In order for them to do so, though, the situation, as far as energy and velocity are concerned, is the reverse of what we are accustomed to.

In our slow-universe, a motionless body has zero energy, but as it gains energy it moves faster and faster, and at infinite energy it speeds up to light-velocity. In the swift-universe, a tachyon with zero energy moves at infinite speed; and the more energy it gains the slower it moves, until with infinite energy it slow downs to light velocity.

In our slow-universe, a body cannot go faster than light under any circumstances. In the swift-universe, a tachyon cannot go slower than light under any circumstances. The light-velocity is the boundary between the two universes and it cannot be crossed.

But do tachyons really exist? All Feinberg has shown is that it is possible to have a swift-universe that does not violate Einstein's theory; but to be possible doesn't necessarily mean to be.

Feinberg points out, though, that if a tachyon moves through a vacuum at faster-than-light speeds, it must leave a trail of potentially detectable light as it goes. Of course, most tachyons would go extremely fast - millions of times as fast as light.

Ordinary tachyons and their flashed of light would have passed us long before we could spot them. Only the very occasional high-energy tachyons would pass us at speeds nearly as slow as that of light. Even then, these would cover a mile in something like $1/200,000$ of a second, and spotting them would be a most delicate operation.

HAVE YOUR OWN UFO RECEIVER

For years, eerie and unintelligible radio signals have been recorded throughout the scope of our globe. Their existence is undeniable, and even the respectable magazine "Radio-TV Experimenter" has pondered upon their meaning.
