

DID STRANGE SPACECRAFT WATCH THE METEOR SHOWER OF.....I833?

\*\*\*\*\*

On November 13, 1833, a tremendous meteoric display had many people in this WORLD gazing awe-struck at an extravagant celestial cinerama.....

The meteoric out-burst began at roughly 2:00 a.m. and was visible until dawn.

Although the meteor shower was visible over much of the country, it was predominantly visible within the longitudinal limits of 61 degrees in the Atlantic Ocean and 100 degrees in Central Mexico, and from the Great Lakes to the island of Jamaica.

The sky was cloudless and all the witnesses were afforded a good unobstructed view of the "fireballs and fiery lines darting across the heavens!"

It was described by many people as being "the most magnificent sight they had ever seen."

There was, however, one very puzzling aspect involved.....

Some witnesses were rather awed and surprised when.....- there - amongst the "fireballs" and fast moving "fiery streaks," there appeared a "variety of luminous bodies which remained in view for some time and appeared to be..... NEARLY STATIONARY."

To say that they remained in view for some time, is to say that they were not visible until dawn. Therefore, since it was cloudless, we can rule out the possibility of stars.

Next, we find that they appeared to be nearly stationary!

THEY WERE MOVING!

They could not have been meteors or..... "falling stars" since neither one of these could have appeared to be..... "nearly stationary" or, in other words, "slow moving."

The terms "luminous body" and "nearly stationary" have been employed over and over again by reputable persons when describing flying saucer observations!

The evidence seems to indicate that on NOVEMBER 13, 1833, millions of people were eye-witness to a strange phenomenon that would later be observed by people the world over!

The evidence also seems to indicate that, while the observers of this world watched the great meteor shower of 1833, the observers from "OUT THERE" were quite busy,

According to a newspaper, of Newark, N.J., a mass of gelatinous substance, like soft soap, had been found.

"It possessed little elasticity, and on the application of heat, it evaporated as readily as water."



For Folks Who Do Not Believe In Sea Monsters, This Fellow Is Forty Feet Long, Sharply Pointed Snout And Nine-Foot Elephant-Like Tusks. Experts Declare Positively That The Beast Is NOT A Whale. (whatzit?)

As is well known by now, cryobiologists are able to take living red corpuscles at room temperature, plunge them into a medium at 345 degrees below zero and then resuscitate them, provided they thaw them out as fast. They have run similarly successful experiments with spermatozoa and even fertilized rabbit-ova. They are progressively succeeding with more and more complicated organisms in lower and lower temperatures.

These truly scientific developments plus the recent discovery of live monsters, which experts (taxonomers) cannot fit into the animal kingdom at this time, lead me to believe that GOD, through His laws of nature, has deep-frozen eons ago many and various organisms, which, given the proper circumstances, thaw out and revive.

Considering the huge size of this animal the increasingly great number of humans plowing on, under or above the oceanic surface, or living, working and playing on or near the beaches, I feel that someone, somewhere, sometime or other would have come in contact with this beast's relatives through his eyes, or nose, camera, binoculars, etc. etc.

I submit that none as far as we know were contacted, because there weren't anymore, at least not many of them. How do I explain this solitary specimen? He and many others like him, thousands, perhaps millions of years ago, suddenly deep-froze in a cake of ice because of some cataclysmic change, like for instance a sudden change of direction in the earth's axis.

Then "accidentally" it drifted right over a sub-oceanic volcanic eruption, which had enough heat to thaw out almost instantaneously "casket" and "cadaver", melting away the one and resuscitating the other.

Another and as fantastic riparian event in the same general area may help to explain this one or vice versa:

A few days before and up to December 21, 1961, along a 200 mile Australian coastline, "millions of fish" of many kinds, some weighing up to 20 pounds, swam with their heads above water and hurled themselves on the beach.

The experts, one of them with 40-years experience in that field, said they had never seen anything like that and that they had no satisfactory explanation.

I suggest that one or perhaps a school of these recently de-iced prince of the oceans, charged at them with a pre-historic weapon, say an electromagnetic ray, against which modern fish have no defense, having survived in their evolutionary struggle against enemies with different weapons. Probably this "beam" although not lethal in itself, disrupted the fishes "radar system" and caused them to panic!

Further support for my hypothesis that prehistoric animals, having been in suspended animation for ages, are now actively living again, will be found soon, I hope and pray, by polar - explorers, who will apply the above-mentioned principles of cryobiology when they thaw out frozen organisms.

Every ufologist now knows that around 1954 scientists in Paris ate mammoth steak from an animal which had been encased in ice for thousands of years. Since these pachyderms were tropical and since the fodder found in their mouths and stomachs was yet unaffected by the digestive enzymes, it is logically assumed that some very SUDDEN cataclysmic upheaval froze them there on the spot with lightning speed while entombing them in freezing water. I suggest that this cold was so fast, so all-embracing and so intense that it didn't remove life, but just arrested it; and that careful cryobiologists would have resuscitated them by applying very intense and all-covering heat

such as would be found in a bath of water saturated with various dissolved minerals and boiling under fabulous pressure, such, as I presume, is found naturally between a tall column of ocean water and the gurgitating "mouth" of a violently active sub-oceanic volcano. The resultant turbulence, caused by the great disequilibrium of the various forces at work, would be just the thing required for the proper application and distribution of heat.

Not only a quick-freeze-thaw, but also dehydration, implantation of certain chemicals will cause in varying degrees of success a dormancy-resuscitation - phenomenon.



On December 19, 1963, it was disclosed that the moon has been the scene of some rather inexplicable occurrences. **Mysterious Moon Eruptions Confirmed By Sightings.**

CAMBRIDGE, MASS. (AP) - Mysterious eruptions on the moon have received added confirmation in a scientific quiz game from one astronomer to another.

Charles Federer, editor of Sky and Telescope magazine, published at Harvard College Observatory, said today two separate sightings of the latest eruptions seems to rule out the possibility of human error.

The latest sightings were made Nov. 27 by a scientific team headed by Dr. John S. Hall, director of Lowell Observatory, Flagstaff, Ariz.

A ruby colored spot observed near the crater Aristarchus was estimated to be 12 miles long and  $\frac{1}{2}$  miles wide, the marking lasted an hour and fifteen minutes.

Eruptions on the moon were first reported Nov. 3, 1958.

Astronomers differ on the cause. Since the latest phenomena were sighted shortly after that portion of the moon returned to the sunlight, some scientists believe surface heating of the moon may have caused the release of a carbon gas in a form not known on this earth. (over)

MYSTERIOUS MOON ERUPTIONS.....(cont. from pge 5)

It is always a sobering thing to see news with such far-reaching implications received with such a detached air of complacency.

However, if the average person was aware that these "mysterious eruptions" are not half as puzzling as some of the OTHER things that have been observed on our lunar satellite, he would do more than give a casual glance to news of new disturbances on the moon.

He would turn his thoughts back to the time when astronomers reported the appearance of strange dome-shaped objects on the moon.

They would remember the reports of flashing lights, a bridge-like structure, strange objects and.....but wait, -- For the benefit of our readers who are not familiar (yet) about such events, it would be of interest to note some of the strange observations that have been recorded.....

In 1829, a man named Gruithuisen noted some strange markings north of the crater Schroeter. The markings consisted of criss-crossed lines and squares that bore a strong resemblance to long-range aerial photos of city blocks and streets. Other city-like markings were found in the craters Plato and Gassendi.

In 1915, a long black wall suddenly appeared in the crater Aristarchus. It ran from the center of the crater to the edge of one rim. One of the strangest mysteries on the moon, is the mystery of the crater Linne.

Up until about 84 years ago, Linne was just a small black crater located on the portion of the moon known as Mare Serenitatis. One night an astronomer named Schmidt, was looking at Linne, when it suddenly changed from a black cone to a white pyramid! Then.....it disappeared completely!

Astronomers were amazed..... but they had seen nothing of the many tricks Linne was to prove capable of pulling. Just when they were getting used to the idea of a vanishing crater, it suddenly re-appeared!

Linne then pulled another disappearing act.- This time it stayed away so long that moon maps were changed, leaving Linne off the new ones.- After the new maps were printed, you guessed it..... Linne disappeared.....once again! Linne has now changed to a large grey spot that changes shape and size.....!!

\*In 1877, a large object was seen in the crater Hyginus. The object disappeared and came back a year later. This was repeated one more time and then the object vanished for good.

\*During the eclipse of 1949, Aristarchus was alive with moving spots, glowing lights and other strange manifestations.

\*In 1916, a red-tinted shadow swept over Plato., also in 1869, thirty bright lights broke out all at once on the floor of crater Plato.

\*They sorted themselves into groups and then one group would flare up while the other darkened. The phenomenon was observed until 1871.

\*Recorded observations numbered 1,600 and 37 graphs of the light fluctuations were drawn.

\*Astronomers talked of "intelligent attempts to signal earth."

\*Between 1860 and 1879, about a dozen dome-shaped objects arrived on the moon. The domes now number over 200, and what they are is a complete mystery. (or is it?)

\*In 1953, Dr. Percy Wilkins observed a structure which looked like a bridge. When asked about it, he replied..... "The bridge is there, and it appears almost like an engineering job."

\*In November 1962, four mysterious hot spots were detected on the moon! So there you have a brief summary of our moon as seen by some people.

Oh yes, incidently..... Someone has beaten us to the moon! This inevitable conclusion stares us in the face.....or so it seems, but, WHO CARES.....??

The following newspaper account is described in detail, as it was printed in the "St John Valley Times", in Maine.

The newspaper heading has been reproduced as authentically as possible. The headline and story went as follows.....

## TIMES RECEIVES MORE REPORTS OF UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECTS...

David and Michael Saunders of Ft. Kent looked up from their play about dusk to see a silver disc glide through the sky from north to south. This is the second recent sighting of an unidentified flying object in the Valley. They called their mother and grandmother from the house, but by the time the adults arrived, the object had disappeared over the hill.

The boys, aged nine and eight, are sons of David Saunders of the immigration Service in Ft. Kent. They saw the object while playing outside their home on the Frenchville Road on Sunday, August 18.

Their father was away at work at the time. He said that he paid little attention to the story until he saw an item in last week's TIMES reporting a similar incident and asking for reports of other sightings.

Mr. and Mrs. Saunders agree that their boys are not inclined to make up stories. "Especially the older one," Saunders said: "I've learned from experience that when he says he saw something, he is."

The boys said that the object hummed intermittently as it passed, something like a radio which isn't working very well being turned on and off. The object was shaped like two dinner plates stacked with their tops together. It was flying very low, they said; when it passed over the hill, it just cleared the trees.

They said that they are familiar with the appearance of airplanes.

"It didn't have a tail like a helicopter," David said.

"It didn't have propellers or wings," Michael said.

"It was going too slow for a plane."

They judged that it must have crossed the river on its way south. Their father said that this is strange since aircraft are not supposed to cross the border.

Lieutenant Rice of the Public Information Office at Loring Air Force Base said that experimental aircraft, whether American or Canadian, would be very unlikely to cross the international border. Thus the explanation that the object was the product of some AF experiment becomes unlikely.

MORE FLYING OBJECTS REPORTED

FIRST SIGHTING

The first sighting of an unidentified flying object in the Valley occurred at 3:30 a.m. on Saturday, August 17, about 40 hours before the boys in Ft. Kent saw something.

A lone hiker stopped to rest at a road junction about two miles north of Cyr mountain on the road from Birch Point to St. David.

Looking toward the sky south, he saw an object moving slowly toward the northwest. The object seemed oval shaped.

It gave off yellow light, the same color light as the moon.

The observer could not determine the altitude, but it seemed to be as high as the orbit of one of the man-made satellites he saw a couple of years ago. It moved along an extremely irregular course, making frequent turns as sharp as a hundred degrees or more.

No airplane could make such turns.

The speed was hard to determine due to the uncertainty about distance. It appeared to be moving slowly.

The observer watched it for about fifteen minutes during which time it moved from the vicinity of the planet Saturn to the vicinity of the constellation Orion.

The TIMES ran a notice about this sighting in last week's issue. But this notice could not have spurred the imagination of the boys in Ft. Kent, because it was not printed until four days after they had seen their object.

Your front-page article about Ranger - 6 on its way to the moon gave me the biggest thrill of my life, because I feel sure that those of us who have been proclaiming that there is life on other worlds, including the moon, will be vindicated at long last.

Our natural satellite has shown us through the years hundreds of signs of life. The latest ones were detected accidentally very recently by various space scientists, who have been analyzing data furnished by various electromagnetic waves of frequencies from visible light to radio-waves. The "echoes" carried by these radiations reveal more or less the composition and the structure of the object that produces them.

The experts here and abroad have simulated the lunar surface many times in various ways using all kinds of rocks, pebbles, powders, and combinations thereof. They have not yet found a satisfactory model that will stand up in view of all the established facts and principles.

However, they generally agree that the material is lifeless, whatever it is. But, on the other hand, as far as some of the "insignificant" points are concerned, we find plenty of disagreement.

Note well how this theory matches the expressions today's scientists are using to describe the material on the lunar surface inasmuch as it reflects various electromagnetic waves. There are "deep holes, vertical walls, and sharp edges."  
 Others: The powder has a "cobweb-like structure." Another team: There are "deep layers of fluffy material."  
 Still others: The surface of the moon is "fuzzy" to a depth of about an inch, having mostly open spaces as in reindeer moss..... "it's a skeletal fuzz."

How do these expressions match my hypothetical lunar forests, which I contend have been discovered by means of these electromagnetic waves?  
 First, consider the wooly, sheep-like bushes and trees that grow here on earth, v.g. on the Santa Marta mountains, northeastern Colombia.  
 Through eons these species managed to survive and were "selected" by nature because they succeeded in adapting themselves to opposite extremes: very hot and dry summers alternating with Artic winters.

AND HOW ABOUT THE MAIN contradiction in the findings of two different teams of equally qualified experts? "Deep layers of dust," versus "thin layers of dust about one inch thick." If it's really dust!  
 I don't see how you can reconcile the two; if the "echoes" came from wooly

such as I have described, the two descriptions fit perfectly together in the same picture and there is absolutely no contradiction.

The scientists who "saw" thick layers of dust, were "looking" down vertically at and through my soft, wooly trees.  
 The other one apparently contradicting the first was using shorter wave lengths and getting more details: So, he probably got his echoes from the short, dense wooly filaments protecting the large, thick and rubbery leaves.

If the cameras on Ranger-6 had functioned to resolve objects as small as a card table, I would not have been surprised if they had proved what we of the "lunatic fringe" found out a long time ago: Man is not alone in the universe.



FLYING SAUCERS FROM THE SOVIET UNION ???


On October 1, 1957, Soviet scientist Prof. S. Zonshtein made the following statement: "Flying Saucers do exist -- and Russia has them!"

The Soviets repeated their claim to ownership of flying saucers last year when, on February 18, the following item was carried by - UPI.

RED "FLYING SAUCER"

Moscow--(UPI)-- The official army newspaper, Red Star, reported last night that Soviet engineers have successfully tested a "flying saucer" aircraft which apparently has both powered and glider uses.

The report said the aircraft is able to take-off vertically, indicating it has its own power source, and also lands on a cushion of air.

The illustration accompanying the title of this article is a copy of a sketch that appeared in the Russian newspaper "Sovietskaya Rossiya" on October 5, 1957.

According to the report that went along with the sketch, it portrays a jet-propelled "flying platform" that has an enclosed cockpit and four vertical supporting legs.

The question of whether or not Russia actually does have working models of disc-shaped aircraft has been a constant cause for intense concern among the people of the free world.

Due to the fact that many people are prone to dismiss the entire UFO subject, on the premise that "such fantastic machines can't possibly exist," the editors propose to offer evidence that:  
1 - There is absolutely nothing fantastic about a disc-shaped flying machine.  
2 - There is good reason to believe that Russia has been successful at developing a working model of a flying saucer.

Consider for example, the fact that.... as far back as 1910, a doughnut-shaped aircraft was in existence!

The doughnut-shaped craft, which was introduced by a man named August Klein, was built by the Italian Caproni Aircraft Works, and, although it was not successful, it is important to note the reason why.

Another ring-shaped aircraft was proposed in 1940 by a German engineer named Hermann.

While there is no evidence that any of the aforementioned devices ever got off the ground, they have been mentioned here to show..., the idea is not new!

For those who, while willing to admit that the idea is not new, still think of it as being "fantastic," let us see what aerodynamic experts have to say. 

In December of 1953, the following incident was made public. The incident had taken place four months previously, in August, 1953.

SPITZBERGEN - 1953

"A flying saucer has been found in the inhospitable snow and ice of Northeast Spitzbergen, a Norwegian island north of Russia, according to unverified intelligence reports."

The object looked like a silver disc, made of unknown metal, with jet motors which made the disc turn around a little dome of transparent plastic. In this dome were several instruments. There was sufficient space to house atomic or other bombs. The action-radius is estimated to be 30,000 kilometers, the attainable altitude about 160 kilometers.

The object was found by six Norwegian jets on summer maneuvers. Their radar instruments indicated red meaning the approach of an unknown metal object.




Illustration of photograph taken by Cedric Allingham on February 18, 1954 just prior to the saucer's landing... One of a series of photos taken by Allingham.

By accident, the commander looked below him and saw on the frozen ground a great metal shining disc among a tangle of wires. In the center of the disc was a partly destroyed steering cabin.

While circling around the object, the pilots saw no sign of any life. They went to Narvik and told of their discovery. Shortly after, five planes equipped with skis landed near the disc.

The rocket specialist, Dr. Norsel, who went with the planes, said the disc was without doubt one of the famous - - - "flying saucers."

In the disc was a transmitter, surrounded by a nucleus of plutonium. It transmitted on all wave-lengths an unknown measuring sound.

The object, probably from Russia, has been brought by ship to Narvik, Norway.

Flagstaff, Arizona-(AP) Dr. Kal Rakas was the only one to report anything close to a sighting through his 21-inch reflector telescope at the Lowell Observatory, in Flagstaff, Arizona. It showed a small flash 50 or 60 miles from the area 90 seconds before impact time.

This sighting is being investigated!

In Moscow, the soviet news agency Tass reported Ranger VI had hit the moon, but said the main purpose of the launch was to transmit pictures back to earth. Tass quoted United Press International as saying:-  
"The moon experiment has ended in failure, as the television equipment did not work."

Several reports were received at JPL(Jet Propulsion Laboratory) which controlled Ranger VI during its 66-hour, 240,000 mile voyage saying:-

"THE SPACE CRAFT HAD MISSED ITS TARGET!"

A spokesman for JPL (newspapers did not identify the spokesman) said.....  
"There is no doubt Ranger landed in the Sea of Tranquility, within 15 miles of the aiming point as determined during the mid-course trajectory correction maneuver." - - "I don't know what these other people saw but it couldn't have been Ranger VI."

The latest contradictory report came Monday (Feb. 3) from Lewellyn Evans, head of the moon-watch team at the University of Chattanooga's Jones Observatory. Evans told newsmen he saw Ranger VI disappear behind the moon!

"Not for a while, anyway."



Trying to cover up the fact that there are far too many unidentified objects in our waters and in the sky, does not qualify issuing information of a low intellectual calibre!






