





From Ray again! - 6/5/64

Here is the form you sent me. I'm sure I have all the information down correctly, as my mother still has the letter she wrote to my dad which has a full description of the object, the time, and so on. Although it was over 5 years ago, I remember everything that happened. -

We were living in a nice 4-room house in the country, about 8 or 9 miles from the nearest town. That night, at 8:45 p.m., Mother went out to a small storage in our backyard. She had only been outside for a few minutes when she noticed a very bright light, which was low in the western sky, moving slowly in an easterly direction toward our house.

Mother went to the back door and told me to hurry outside. When I did, she asked me if I saw anything in the sky? I told her I saw a "funny looking fuzzy light." When I first saw it, it appeared to be a fuzzy light, but after watching it for about ten minutes the object came close enough for us to clearly see its unusual shape. Then it stopped and hovered for about 3 minutes. We noted that it appeared to be large and at a higher altitude than when we first saw it. It had a very bright luminous glow that was white in color.

Although we heard no sound, our cat "SMOKEY" who was in the house at the time, was looking out the window and howling wildly as if it sensed or heard something that frightened it! I went in the house and turned off all the lights so we could see the object better. While we watched it, it started moving upward gaining altitude. Then it stopped and made a zig-zag motion. Then went up still higher and suddenly disappeared.

It was now 9:15 p.m. We had been watching it for about 30 minutes. We waited a while longer but it did not reappear. We went back in the house. We noticed the cat had quit howling, but was still very scared. I'm sure that the object we saw was not a mirage or hallucination. Mother and I had never been interested in Flying Saucers., in fact, I had never heard of such a thing at the time. I've never heard of anyone seeing a UFO with this exact shape.


After seeing that UFO, it wasn't long until we became very interested in the subject of Flying Saucers. Since then I've kept my eyes open and I hope to see another one, but doubt if I ever will!

Dear Mr. Ferriere:

Thank you for your letter of May 19, offering me a position as Arizona representative for your fine publication, CPB. I thankfully accept. If you like, you can make it "teen-age" representative, since I am a sixteen-year old high school student. I personally don't care. Please let me know soon what you expect of me. While I won't part with single clippings, for reasons outlined below, I will be glad to have Thermo-Fax copies made.

I am planning to start a mimeographed saucer publication soon. I will have a somewhat different outlook from CPB. I doubt if they will conflict much. I can appreciate what a job putting out a saucerzine is. I have already purchased a subscription to CPB, but I will put your name or CPB on my mailing list to receive the zine and any pamphlets I may put out. After my CPB subscription runs out, we can exchange if you like. This will be a convenient way for me to obtain information. If you have any information I could use for the first issue, please let me know or send it if possible. By the way, I am planning a bi-monthly at first, and later hope to expand to a monthly. Let me know if you are interested in any of the above. In any case, I'll send you a little promo I have in mind as soon as I can cut a stencil and run it off.

I will do my best to promote CPB here, but there are few other saucer fans.

Regarding your report of a contact-type saucer report in New York: I personally don't believe any of the contactee stories I've heard so far. Too many are so wild that they become ridiculous or downright laughable. The editorial policy of my publication will be my own philosophy of life, skepticism and withholding of belief unless sufficient proof is given, or unless it holds with known physical laws of science. However, we will print almost any clipping or article, as long as it is reasonable and literate. I was thinking of soliciting an article from you or your associate, or both jointly, concerning either a subject of your own choice, or the activity of saucer groups in the East.

My own journal will consist more of such informational, theoretical or historical articles than of current sightings, unless they bear on the former. Current sightings are well covered by publications such as CPB, but the former, I believe, are definitely lacking on the contemporary scene. I hope to build the publication into a standard reference for various theories and histories of saucerdom. It will supplement publications such as CPB.

I have heard from NICAP by post-card about ABC-TV's planned UFO programs. If you have any more recent information on them, let me know. I'd hate to miss one, and would like to tape-record them.

Well, if you'll have me after this too-lengthy letter and its contained revelations, I very much want to be your Arizona representative. Please let me know soon about your reactions to the above.

Dear Joe:

I will see that you and Armand get the Review etc. Thanks for the illustrations.

Thank you for your kind words about the committee. I must say that the REVIEW and its supplements will become much better as time advances. Right now we have plans to set up an office as national hq. If the rent is right we will move in. Then plans to expand the committee will push on.

I accept the post of District Representative gladly, and to start off right I give you this report... "The Star Beacon, Ashtabula, Ohio - May 16. UFO ZOOMS FROM NEAR RT. 90, INTERCHANGE-- An unidentified flying object near Geneva on Interstate Rt. 90 was reported to the Ohio State Highway Patrol at 11:51 p.m. Friday, the patrol said. According to the Patrol's report a resident of Long Beach, Calif., eastbound on Rt. 90, observed a large object on the ground in the bushes on the south side of the eastbound lane between Rt. 534 and Rt. 45. It was the size of a big tractor trailer truck, he said. The caller said the object changed color, turning to a bright orange or flame color, hovered about eight feet off the ground and then took off and soared to about 300 to 400 feet. At this point the flame color became a blur and zoomed into the sky. This happened about 11:30 p.m. The motorist said a driver of a semi-trailer rig also saw the UFO and stopped. The Californian called the Patrol from a pay station near a service station on Rt. 45, the Patrol - said. The Patrol is checking the area today. The caller did not pinpoint the exact spot where the UFO was first seen."

May I add that a reliable source told me that several Air Force cars were seen parked near the touch-down spot that night with their lights on. Also Patrol investigators were told to go about their business and let the Air Force investigate. There were several men (AF men) described as "BRASS" at the scene.

I have been very busy with Congress plans and have had to devote most of my time to this purpose.

I am sorry to see that you can't attend the Congress but I will inform you of its progress.



The following is the tale of a man who lived in fear, and who possibly still has not gotten over his harrowing experiences!

He does not know if he fears the " SAUCERS " because he is still bewildered from his near contact with one. But, he lives in fear of ridicule.....



..... Only after much prompting from his good friend Joe Ferriere, who assured him that many people had seen saucers and as good citizens reported them, did he release the following.....

His name? - - Mr. Everett Ducharme of Woonsocket, R.I., and his letter, now in the files of CPB, is dated October 11th., 1962. - Received by - Joe Ferriere!

What prompted this letter to be sent seems to stem from the following interview with Joe in trying to gather information for a zine that he thought would print it, but never did! (the zine will remain nameless., but a portion of it was - released by Joe, to INS, which printed the contact part.- near contact that is.)

The interview (by Joe) with Mr. Ducharme, who names 14 witnesses to the following- June 2nd 1962 Age: 41 Occupation: Grinder Military Service: U.S. Army - Infantry. Witnesses: Oscar Ducharme (son) Edgar Ricard, Mr. and Mrs. Desautel and son Robert, Conrad Bellangier, Francis Seatiar, Mr. and Mrs. Hunt with their daughter Ann, Sandra Menard, Sue Bouley, Sue Desautel and Vivian Bouley.

Date of sighting: Last part of June 1961. - The objects were sighted every night for a period of 2½ weeks. Place of sighting: Corner of East & Olo streets in Woonsocket, Rhode Island. Time: Between 8:30 and 9:00 p.m., approximate time each night. No. of objects: 2 at the least and 14 at the most., varied nightly. Approximate height: Lowest ½ mile - Highest 2 miles up. Speed: The things disappeared just like that, he said, snapping his fingers for emphasis. Size: - Like basketballs. Appearance: They seemed to be perfectly round with a bright red self-illuminating light., also they seemed to be smooth and metallic.

Sound: None. Any visible means of propulsion?: No, none at all. Performance of objects: They appeared from the south at a terrific rate of speed, stopped, hovered for 3 or 4 minutes, then accelerated at a high rate of speed. They followed an irregular series of circles, went back and forth, seemed to spin and also wobble, then they vanished toward the northeast.

Duration of the sightings: 15 to 20 minutes each night for 2½ weeks.

Other reports on these famous sightings were reported to radio station WWON in Rhode Island! - - But..., people who called in to report their sightings were told that they were.....WEATHER BALLOONS!

Mebbe so, but it sounds like a lot of hot air in the air at one time., or...was it a lot of hot air coming over the air? (over please)

The Letter From Mr. Ducharme.....

October 11th 1962

Dear Mr. Ferriere:

I have sighted several things I haven't told to anyone because I believe them to be impossible. I still can't hardly believe it myself. What I saw frightened me very much!

I was alone when it happened, that is why I don't know whether to believe it or not.

I will be frank with you, I never believed in those UFO's, but now it is another thing entirely. - I do believe., and I have a feeling that some intelligent beings, yes, I said intelligent beings, from outer space are trying to make contact with us. They are just as frightened of us as we are of them, it seems. Maybe I have the wrong slant on things, but that's how I feel! Don't you agree with me? I will tell you what I saw and what happened to me, then you can take it from there.

I went to Chepachet, R.I., and I decided to walk through the woods I am fond of. It was nearly sundown. I know those woods like I know the back of my hand. - I was born and brought up around there. - Well, anyway, I came to this open field that has a stream on one side of it, where I decided to rest.

As I sat there the sun just sinking on the horizon, I heard a hum in the air. At first I didn't pay much attention to it., but then the hum began to get louder and louder. It wasn't a steady hum, it was just like your pulse beating in your ears.

I never heard anything like it. All at once I saw a black shape in the sky which was very large and coming at a very terrific speed. It stopped right over my head!

Was I afraid? - I was terrified! - I could not move! - I was frozen to the spot! - Then, the pulse beats stopped, and all was quiet. - Suddenly - it felt like something was probing my brain! - Then I ran, yes, somehow I managed to run, and I never went back there again., and I don't want to!

That same incident happened to me three or four times, in different places!!

I am telling you this for you people look for such information, but I have no one else to back me up because I was alone.

I thought I would tell you anyway. Do you think I was actually picked out for them to make contact with me? - Or what?


It is still hard for me to believe at times that it really did happen. But I know it is true, for it actually happened to me!



LAROCHELLE

DRAGGER - 3 ABOARD, VANISH IN MYSTERY! -- Yes, dear readers, it has happened..... again! This time it is the fishing vessel "?" yes, that's it's name, "The Question" It was lost in the Atlantic off Martha's Vineyard on April 22, 1964, after a frantic "Mayday" from the 40-foot dragger. A quantity of dead fish was found in an area 20 miles of "No Man's Land" in the general area where the boat radioed the distress call. Aboard the dragger were the owner's son, Joseph Fitzpatrick Jr., of Harbor Island, Narragansett, R.I. - George Carlton, of Narragansett and Larry (no not Larochelle wise guys!) Rawdon of Wakefield, Rhode Island.....

COAST GUARD ALERTED

The boat, out of Pt. Judith, R.I., was apparently on its way back to its home port when another fishing boat, the Jo Ann, intercepted the garbled message which indicated the dragger was sinking fast.

The Jo Ann transmitted the message by radio telephone to the Point Judith Coast Guard Station. Four helicopters and a search & rescue plane from the Salem Coast Guard Base flew to the scene immediately. Also dispatched were the cutters Pt. Cypress and Pt. Jefferson. Also a 44-foot boat from Pt. Judith.

The air units searched for over 2 hours before heavy fog and darkness curtailed the search area. The surface vessels continued the hunt through the night although visibility was zero.

What was baffling the Coast Guard officials was the question of what happened to the "Question" for it to vanish so suddenly? - No debris was ever found and at the time the distress call was heard, the sea was calm, said the Coast Guard.

MYSTERIOUS SHIP IS HUNTED

The Coast Guard searched in vain for a fishing vessel on the basis of a very mysterious radio message received on June 27th 1963, saying the crew was abandoning ship.

Several Coast Guard Stations reported hearing a message at 2:35 a.m., which said, May Day - May Day - this is the Mary Ann...60 miles southeast of..... Provincetown - engine trouble - engine is spurting oil.....

Ten minutes later another message came - May Day - May Day - emergency - vessel sinking - two passengers are injured - abandon ship..... Two minutes later another message: - This is my last transmission - abandoning ship - 90 miles - southeast of Provincetown.

The Coast Guard cutter Acushnet and two amphibious planes searched in vain.

The Coast Guard also tried to determine what the vessel's home port might be. - Efforts proved fruitless as no New England ports knew of a vessel named Mary Ann which was unaccounted for.....!

(will you look at that ridiculous illustration that Joe drew up for this serious article? - Oops - I mean serious of course! - turn page please.....) - (LARRY!)

Trouble afoot? - No, trouble Asea!
More trouble on Thursday June 1964 beset the freighter Pomona, which was plagued earlier by the ax slaying of her skipper and a fire in her engine room.

The skipper's slaying in May forced a layover in Honolulu on a scrap metal trip from Los Angeles to Formosa while one wary crew quit and another signed on.

Wednesday, while 100 miles south - west of Honolulu on the resumed journey the fire broke out. Most of the crew took to life - rafts, then got back on the ship after the fire was controlled and the freighter was taken in tow for a return to Honolulu.

Thursday, she had rudder trouble, requiring repairs at sea and the steering mechanism went awry also.

The tugboat Lihue II reported the Pomona's rudder was "locked hard right and we are towing her at a 45-degree angle."

The radio message said: "If the Pomona gets the steering fixed we will get there - Honolulu - tomorrow."

Another crew for this ill-fated ship may be hard to come by now that it has become a "jinx ship."

Freak Wave Capsizes Boat

Worcester Telegram - 5/8/64
Salisbury Beach (AP) One person drowned, two others are missing and six were rescued last night after a 21-foot outboard motor - boat capsized.

Police quoted one survivor as saying a big wave struck the small boat broadside and toppled it.

Huge, unexpected waves arising from calm seas or near calm seas are still a mystery today.

In September of 1963, Cmdr. of the destroyer Hazelwood, Donald Hanson, blamed a "three wave phenomenon" for the loss of the ships' liberty boat and one of its crew. - Other witnesses corroborated the unusual event.

THE MYSTERY OF THE SS OURANG MEDAN - - -

Something strange was menacing the Dutch vessel as she beat her way through the straits of Malacca in February of 1948.

The ship flashed a series of frantic distress calls which were picked up by Dutch and British radio centers. The radio operator on the Ourang Medan kept sending S.O.S. calls...

"All officers including the captain dead, lying in the chartroom and on the bridge..... probably whole crew dead." - Suddenly the message became garbled. - Another call for help, then the final message.....
"I die," followed by complete silence!

Rescue craft from the Sumatra and Malaya found the Ourang Medan right where she had reported herself, but there was no response to their calls to her. - When the boarding parties clambered to her deck they found themselves in a floating morgue. - There was the master of the vessel on his back dead, one hand thrown back to cover his eyes.

In the wireless room, the operator who had tried desperately to get help was slumped in his chair, his lifeless hand still lying across the transmitting key. - In the wheel - house were the bodies of officers, piled across each other on the floor. - The corpses of the crew were scattered throughout the vessel, some in their bunks, others where they had fallen.

On the face of every corpse was an expression of stark terror. - Even the captain's pet dog died on the deck with its teeth bared in anger, or agony!

In a report filed with the Merchant Marine Council, the officers of the rescue vessels said they found no traces of violence, no wounds or injuries on any of the bodies. They agreed to tow the stricken vessel with her grisly cargo into the nearest port. But while they were talking about it, flames burst out between decks. - The would-be rescuers abandoned the ship when they found they were unable to control the fire.

Minutes later the Ourang Medan exploded and sank from sight!!

What horrible thing or things could have caused such a tragedy? - What? - -



Bjorne Haugen, 45, who arrived here
recently from Norway, was at the wheel
about 6 p.m., Tuesday, when he spied

Nantucket.

Since marker buoys can't do that, the excited Bjorne called to engineer Alf Wilhelmsen who was on duty with him. He queried, in a rough translation from the Norwegian, "What the hell do you think that thing is?" Those who were not on duty were below drinking - - - coffee!

A FRIENDLY SORT..... At this point, the sea serpent, who fortunately was a friendly sort, swam to within 50 feet of the boat and for a while kept pace with the Bruce C, which was cruising at eight knots per hour. Wilhelmsen described the serpent as at least 50 feet long and weighing between 35 and 40 tons, with an alligator-like head rising some 25 feet above the water.

Its body had several humps, or ridges, and there was a large blow hole at the base of his skull. The sea serpent paced the boat for about five minutes, then took off. Both Wilhelmsen and Haugen agreed the serpent was headed toward Boston when it left them!

Inverness, Scotland (UPI) - Scotland's legendary Loch Ness monster came up for air Friday when someone was looking. It made its latest appearance before "eyewitnesses" a few hours before a fishing boat discovered an unidentified object with its echo sounder.

The fishing drifter "Girl Norma" was sailing west on the deep inland lake when the sounder recorded vibrations of an object estimated to be 30 feet long at 40 fathoms. The boat was in the same part of the Loch where three men reported seeing the "monster" for several minutes.

The men, working on a new road about 300 feet above the Loch, said visibility was perfect and the water very calm when they saw an object cruising along the surface. They said it was about three feet above the surface and 15 feet long.

The men said the object suddenly sped away at 25 miles per hour with a "terrific wash," then stopped completely and a minute later submerged.

There has been speculation the monster, if it really exists, is a creature of the giant pre-historic type that may somehow escaped extinction.

Numerous expeditions have been made to Loch Ness to spot the creature. The latest attempt is being made by eight English College students who are using high frequency and echo sounding equipment.

"The thing was about a mile away. It was black and seemed to have a hide-like skin. There was about 15 feet of it showing above the water, but I didn't see any head."

"Everybody was stone cold sober," he added as an afterthought.

There are scientists who are convinced there is certainly something big in the lake.

Others scorn the theory.

Robot Space Camera Bared

WASHINGTON (UPI)—The Air Force unveiled a robot space camera called the Remote Maneuvering Unit (RMU), with characteristics as fantastic as some of those attributed to flying saucers.

Only 29 by 26 by 10½ inches a rectangular flying box with a protruding lens—the RMU was first tested at high altitude this week, the Air Force said, and is to operate in space in the “not too distant future.”

The “thing,” while under radio control from a mothering space ship, will be able to:

- Speed to great distances from the mother ship to photograph unidentified objects which might be enemy satellites, weapons or vehicles.
- Maneuver about the object

to get photographs from various angles while televising these instantaneously back to the space ship as well as making film that can be processed later.

● Return to the mother ship when its objective is completed, to resume its place on any shelf large enough to hold a two-suitcase.

THE RMU weighs less than 125 pounds. It has 16 propulsion nozzles and three guidance gyroscopes, all under remote radio control. It was built by Ling-Temco-Vought's Chance Vought Division at Dallas, Tex.

The first of 20 scheduled high-altitude tests was conducted Wednesday from Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Dayton, Ohio in a specially designed

transport which flew in a pattern enabling it to achieve a condition of weightlessness for 90 seconds.

This provided an opportunity to observe operation of the nozzles and gyros in a condition of weightlessness during static tests within the transport.

The first realistic test out in space may be from the Air Force's Manned Orbiting Laboratory (MOL), a space ship about 20 by 10 feet which is scheduled to fly next year.

The RMU could be used to inspect either unknown or known objects for scientific observations,” the Air Force said. “The space ship crew has radio control of the RMU, which also is guided by visual sighting and television.”

He reads encyclopedias from time to time, magazines and books, but prefers the newspaper. His parents say he frequently reads the newspaper through, and remembers most of what he has read.



His father, Paul Jones Sr., a drop forge worker, left school after the eighth grade. His mother left high school.


His mother was particularly anxious to have him read well for a visiting newsmen. Paul wanted to ride his new bike.

GREAT UFO SIGHTINGS OF THE 60s⁺

No. 1 - SAO PAULO, BRAZIL - 1963

On October 31, 1963, at 2:30 P.M. several people on the banks of the Paropava River, in Sao Paulo Province, Brazil, heard a loud roar. Looking up they were startled to see a shiny disc-shaped object. It was coming in at a very low altitude, just above the house of Mrs. Elidia Alves de Souza. At the side of this house, near the river, stands a palm tree. As the object passed the tree it gouged the side of it near the top. Then the disc began some erratic maneuvers which suggested that it was having difficulty regaining its flight attitude after the collision. Suddenly, it plunged into the river near the shore, opposite the de Souza house.

Witnesses said later that when the object came into contact with the water it was as if a hot iron had fallen into cold water. The water began to bubble and surged up at that spot. Witnesses to the sighting (besides Mrs. de Souza) included Rute de-Souza, Raul Alves de Souza and Tetsuo Ioshigawa. As of this writing all attempts to retrieve the disc have been negative.

Two other witnesses, Antonio de Souza and Justine Nunes Veiga, expressed what seems to be the opinion of all who saw the UFO. They were inclined to think it was " from another world. "

Details can be found in the May 1964 issue of FATE magazine.

Russian astronaut, or as the Russians call them, "cosmonaut," also saw the strange fireflies in the same manner.

Famed test pilot Joe Walker says films taken during a flight in the rocket-powered X-15 experimental plane to a height of 246,700 feet showed five or six mysterious objects.

The objects seemed to be disc-shaped or cylindrical, but impossible to estimate their size or distance from the camera.

Because it changed course, direction and altitude, it appeared to be under - Intelligent Control. NASA prevented Major Cooper from talking about it, later." (March-April issue of LLP - 1964.)

George Adamski is a writer, contactee and amateur astronomer who resided on Mount Palomar, home of the world's largest telescope, the 200 inch mirror reflector.

His book, "Inside The Spaceships," stated the fact that the fireflies were seen from the flying saucers that he supposedly rode in. - All well and good, but as an amateur astronomer, he most certainly knew about the following theory and with a little imagination included it in his book and by mere coincidence termed such as fireflies!

So our theory of the fireflies is based on the following which appeared in..... Sky & Telescope - July issue of 1945 - page eleven. -

DOES THE EARTH HAVE A TAIL?

Like comets, the earth may have a tail, a gaseous tail.

Dr. I.S. Astapowitch proposes this in one of the recent Astronomical Circulars, U.S.S.R., where he describes his visual observations of the counter-glow, more commonly known as the gegenschein. The observed wave lengths suggest that this hazy patch of light may be part of the earth's atmosphere, the light probably originating from the oxygen and nitrogen.

Measurements of the parallax of the gegenschein, difficult to make, indicate distances of from 150,000 to 200,000 kilometers.

This may be the length of a cometary tail of the earth's atmosphere which extends about 50 earth diameters, or well beyond the orbit of the moon.

Particles of this tail would be moving in hyperbolic orbits convex toward the sun, because of the pressure of sunlight.

Newark Valley (UPI) - A farmer from this Southern Tier New York hamlet has told authorities of an encounter with " two little men from Mars looking for some farming information. "

Gary T. Wilcox, 28, also said the visitors warned that earth people would fail in space travel efforts because their bodies could never adapt to the conditions.

Wilcox told Tioga County sheriff's officers that he found a large, shiny, egg-shaped object on one of his two dairy farms April 24. He said it was about 20 feet by 16 feet.

As he approached it, he said, two little " men " came up to him!

Sheriff's officers said Wilcox had an excellent reputation in the area. Neighbors told them Wilcox is " serious, hardworking, doesn't drink and is not excitable."

Sheriff's officers said they were investigating and had no comment to make on the story.

That's the way two employes of the United Screw Machine Products Co., describe one they claim they saw over the city about 10:15 last night.

Ronald N. Laprade (my brother) and Roland C. Progin said the luminous object, shaped like a tear drop and racing at high speed toward the center of the city, seemed to come from the direction of Grafton.

" It had mixed colors," they said, " blue, green, and red with a white tail light. The blue was at the front, or wide end, with the green in the middle and then the red."

The two men, who were at work, said they went to a water bubbler in the shop for a drink. As they passed by a wide, open door, they said, the 'saucer' swished by at a distance of 150 yards and a height of 200 feet,

" It made no noise," they asserted, " and it seemed to be travelling parallel to Grafton street in the direction of City Hall."

Laprade and Progin said they were able to observe the object for about three seconds before their line of vision was blocked by nearby buildings.

At that distance, they said, it looked about the size of an ordinary saucer.

He offered the belief that life is common in the universe and the density of life is such that there are no doubt several populations within the present radio range. He said there have been no contacts with life on other worlds " of any significance, because no real concerted effort has been made."

"Such a contact would have as profound an impact on our world and its culture as did the voyage of Columbus on the old World culture," said Dr. Oliver.

"With our present sending and receiving equipment, our chances of contacting other intelligent life is really quite high, and the cost of such a program would be negligible compared with the impact it would have," he said.

Dr. Oliver was the featured speaker at the banquet session of the IEEE. He is a former vice president.

Recognized at the banquet session with a fellow award was Prof. Obed C. Haycock, director of the University of Utah Upper Air Research Laboratory.



Prof. Haycock was recognized for " contribution to the research on upper atmosphere and to engineering education,"

Thus the existence of our present species depends on a very precise sequence of causative events through some two billion years or more. Man cannot be an exception to this rule. If the casual chain had been different, homo sapiens would not be.

Both courses followed by evolution and its processes clearly show that such evolution is not repeatable. No species of any larger group has ever evolved, or can ever evolve, twice. Man is unique, when he is gone, he will be gone forever according to our evolutionists.



South America - In 1950 Dr. Bossa saw three little dead men dressed in brown suits which enveloped them from head to foot except for the face.

In 1954, Pedro Morais saw two little men of apparently the same size, clad in yellow suits which enveloped them, including the face.

On the night of December 10th 1954; two young boys, Lorenzo Flores and Jesus Gomez of Caroro, Venezuela, were rabbit hunting near the Trans-Andian highway. When they spotted a shiny object which they thought was a car. They approached it and found that it was an aircraft of unusual design.

Orson Welles Monster Come To Life? -



UFO Group To Study

Lawrence Boy's Films

MAY - JUNE, 1964

A Lawrence youth's sightings of Unidentified Flying Objects has been confirmed by the New England UFO Study group.

According to Steven Putnam, president of the New England study group, Kevin Boda of 20 Brookfield street, has bonified films of UFO's, the first such films certified by the group.

"I have no reason to doubt Kevin," said Putnam. "On the film I studied, the object was definitely not man-made."

Kevin, the son of Mrs. Lorraine Boda, first sighted an object on Wednesday, May 6th, from the corner of Lenox and Jefferson streets, looking over the Western Electric plant.

"Look at the plane," a woman shouted. But Kevin looked closely and for the first time in his life took movies of the sky. The movies later produced proof that the object had no natural lights.

Object Glowed

According to Kevin, the object was big and green and surrounded by a glow. He saw the object later on his way home. Both were seen after 9 p. m.

The next time was on May 9th at 9 p. m. on a hill at Jefferson street. At the first sighting the UFO was a spot with a white dot. Later he saw four or five of them over the city.

One was a large dark green object about the center of Tower Hill as he looked in that direction. Another white one was hovering above the hill. Meanwhile a green object was over St. Patrick's church and a larger orange one to right of that one.

But the films as studied by the certifying group revealed another one over the city itself.

On May 10th, the boy was struck by a cloud of what Father Guy Cyr of Sacred Heart church described as UFOLON. Kevin said that the mass of dust was 2 feet by 3 feet and covered him completely. Mr. Putnam on the other hand described the substance as "Angels' Hair," as the ufologist call it, and confirmed the existence of the material. The expert said that it changes quickly from solid to vapor.

As the boy proceeded home, he was again hit by the stuff, this time in front of a witness. The clothing was examined by Father Cyr and confirmed.

25 Years In Priesthood

On May 11 at 9:30 p. m. a dog's whining brought the boy out for a look and he saw an object over the Saunders school change from Red to Green, to Blue and to Yellow. Then the object moved directly over head and disappeared.

Again the next night over Saunders school and every night that week.

On May 13 and 14 the object was in the shape of an oil can with windows. Sort of like a pig's tail.

Strange Shape

On the following night, eight witnesses saw strange shape, and that was the last of the Oil Can. What is believed to be the mother ship was also sighted that night. The object was in three colors with an orange outline.

The night was described as clear, and Kevin says the object passed in front of the moon. The group was standing at the corner of Bowdoin and Mt. Vernon streets, a favorite spot of the UFO watcher.

On May 30, Father Cyr was with the boy when they both sighted one of them.

On June 4th, there were several people with Kevin when a dark green object was seen, which appeared and disappeared, before it was lost over the Tower Hill area.

Only this last Thursday, Kevin sighted five objects during the day (from 3 to 8 p. m.) and eight more at night after 9:30 p. m.

Friday, he saw one about the size of a nickle over Sylvester street that was red, blue and green and another over St. Patrick's church.

Eight film shots taken by Kevin are now being studied by the five state organization.

Study Films

Members of the UFO study group working on the program are Mr. Putman, the president (who is an engineer); Edmund Fogg, an expert photographer; and George Carroll, a film expert.

Their findings state that on one object filmed, a lighting unit on the UFO gave off 40 to 80 flashes a second, "absolutely not man made, and positively could not be built in this country."

"There were four separate lights in one unit with several pinpoint lights surrounding it. There was also another independent light in the shape of a hot dog," Putman said.

"If anyone comes in contact with the UFOLON, Putman has requested that they call him as soon as possible at 545-2125 (Scituate, Mass.). The substance can only be preserved under refrigeration, he said.

Kevin has been requested to present his findings to the New England UFO Study group at their monthly sessions at the American Legion Post 95 Hall, Quincy, on Sunday, July 19.

Evidence Of UFO Landing Here

City Policeman Zamora Reports Sighting Egg-Shaped Object and Views Take-Off; Tourist Sees Craft Just Before Landing

What appears to be substantial evidence of an unidentified flying object landing and taking off in Socorro has been observed.

City Policeman Lonnie Zamora, a highly reliable source, saw a four-legged, egg-shaped object, and two persons in a gully a mile south of the courthouse shortly before 8 p.m. Friday. He saw the object rise straight up and take off, and disappear beyond Six-Mile Canyon to the west. Some of the evidence of the landing and take-off remained in the gully. There were four shallow holes where the object apparently landed on its legs; there were burned greasewood and seared clumps of green grass; there were two round, very slight depressions. No footprints were found.

Zamora said he saw lettering on the side of the UFO, and he sketched the lettering on a paper sack after the object had taken off. He did not believe the lettering was in English and he observed no numerals as there are on known aircraft. Zamora said he was not at liberty to further describe the lettering.

At least one other person — an unidentified tourist traveling north on U. S. 85 — saw the UFO just before it landed in the gully. Opal Grinder, manager of Whiting Brothers' Service Station on 85 north, said the man stopped at the station and remarked that aircraft flew low around here.

Grinder replied there were many helicopters in this vicinity.

The tourist said it was a "funny-looking helicopter, if that's what it was." The man said further the object had flown over his car. It actually was headed straight for the gully where it landed moments later. The tourist also commented that he had seen a police car heading up the hill. This was Zamora's car.

Grinder did not know of the object at the time, and did not attach importance to the traveler's remarks.

A Tucson, Ariz., couple was here Sunday to interview Zamora for a scientific article on the object. The woman said a minister and 26 other persons in New Guinea had seen a similar object hovering for two hours at an estimated altitude of 400 feet. It was reported the observers had seen a man on the "deck" of the object.

Maj. William Conner of Kirtland Air Force Base, Albuquerque, was also here Sunday afternoon to interview Zamora. The major said he was not at liberty to comment. He and an Air Force sergeant visited the UFO scene. Use of a Geiger counter at the scene was reported to have brought negative results.

Capt. Richard T. Holder of Socorro, U.S. Army up-range commander with headquarters at Stallion Range Center on White Sands Missile Range, said Saturday:

"I was contacted on the evening of April 24 by local authorities and asked to provide assistance in identifying a reported UFO. After being appraised of the situation, I attempted to determine whether White Sands Missile Range or Holloman Air Force Base had anything that might produce the conditions described.

Neither White Sands Missile Range nor Holloman had an object that would compare to the object described. There was no known firing mission in progress at the time of the occurrence that would produce the conditions reported."

Zamora doesn't know what the object was, but for those who desire to speculate, there are three possibilities:

First, it may have been a top secret U.S. aircraft in an advanced stage of development.

Second, it may have been an advanced type of aircraft or spaceship of another power.

Third, it may have been a space scout ship from another planet.

Whatever the object was, it probably was the first reported concrete instance of a UFO in New Mexico.

Policeman Zamora shifted from a routine task to a frightening, out-of-this-world experience in a few minutes Friday night.

He was patrolling Park Street where he had begun pursuit of a fast-traveling car several blocks ahead of him. Zamora was almost on the old road when he heard what he described as a blast or a roar. His first thought was that an aluminum building used to store explosives had blown up. He forgot about the speeding car and headed up a very rocky, dirt road towards the building. On the third try, driving very slowly, he managed to get up the road which leads to the top of the mesa overlooking the gully where the UFO had landed.

The policeman said he first saw the object at an estimated distance of 150 yards, and he thought it was an overturned car. He was looking out of his car window as he drove towards the top of the mesa. Zamora said one of two persons at the UFO, whose back was to him, turned his head and looked straight at him. The two persons standing by the object appeared to be dressed in white coveralls, and at the distance Zamora saw them they appeared to be "child-like," that is, small. He did not notice what sort of headgear, if any, the two persons, presumably men, wore.

Zamora continued driving up the hill to get a closer look at the object and the persons. When he stopped his car on the top of the mesa and directly opposite the place in the gully where the UFO had landed, he saw it again, but the persons were not outside the object on which the sun gleamed brightly. He got out of his car and started towards the UFO. Then he again heard the roar or blast that had brought him to the scene and saw flames. Dust was flying around the object.

The policeman believed the object was about to explode. He was about 50 feet from the UFO, and for protection he dropped to the ground and covered his face with an arm.

No explosion occurred, and Zamora also realized the object was not heading in his direction. He raised his head slightly. He saw the UFO, which seemed to be headed south on landing, rise straight up for an estimated 20 feet, which brought it about on a level with the police car on the mesa top. The object appeared to maintain this altitude beyond the explosives building and due west in a straight line for about two miles to the perlite mill. On the other side of the mill the UFO gained altitude very rapidly, passed over Six-Mile Canyon, became a speck in the sky, and disappeared.

Zamora said there was a sharp whining sound at the end of the roar preceding the object's take-off. As the object got into the air, the noise quieted. The object did not leave a jet trail. Reports of other supposed UFO's have mentioned that they fly with little or no noise.

Zamora radioed the sheriff's office immediately after the object had taken off. State Police Sgt. Sam Chavez, State Policeman Ted Jordan, and Undersheriff James Luckie responded. Chavez and Luckie said the burned clumps of green grass and the greasewood were still hot when they arrived. The military later took samples of the burned earth for analysis.

An inspection of the scene Saturday morning showed the object had landed astride a narrow, rock-strewn dry wash in the gully. Officers earlier had circled with stones the four places where the legs of the object had touched earth. The holes were shallow, about a foot long by six inches wide. They did not appear to have been made by an object striking the earth with great force, but by an object of considerable weight settling to earth at slow speed and not moving af-

ter touching the ground.

The two legs of the object that Zamora saw probably were about 2½ feet long.

It was about 12 feet from one landing hole to the other on the west side and 15 feet between the two on the east side. The width probably was nine or more feet.

The clumps of green grass and two greasewood bushes seemed to have been seared all at once by an extremely hot flame. There were also broken branches on one greasewood.

The two round depressions were four and five inches in diameter, respectively.

The cause of the landing of the object, like its identity and its source, remain unanswered. Was the landing in the secluded, little-frequented gully for a test or caused by momentary mechanical difficulty?

After Capt. Holder was appraised of the UFO occurrence, he made a report of it to the proper agencies at WSMR. Investigation of the incident will be conducted by designated government agencies.

By Sunday afternoon hundreds of curious persons had trampled the scene and there was virtually no evidence left of the landing marks.

Air Force Consultant Checks UFO In Socorro Dr. Hynek Feels Zamora Account Is Solid, Not a Hoax

Socorro held the spotlight this week in the investigation of the report of City Policeman Lonnie Zamora that he saw an unidentified flying object last Friday in a gully a mile southwest of the courthouse.

Dr. J. Allen Hynek, special consultant to the Air Force on unidentified flying objects, was here Wednesday at the request of the Air Force. He visited the site with Zamora, talked to him at length there, and interviewed others. He found the site so trampled by the curious that little of scientific value could be obtained.

The scientist said he had not seen a similar sight previously in his investigations.

No radar picked up an object so far as is known, and it should have been picked up if it came in from outer space or was cruising around this area, Hynek said. "This is the outstanding discrepancy in what otherwise is a very solid tale," (Zamora's account). I found nothing that tends to discredit Zamora. This discrepancy concerns me."

Maj. William Conner of Kirtland Air Force Base, Albuquerque, said here Wednesday there were no identified radar targets in this area between April 24 and 28. He came here with Hynek.

"It's a real pity, but no one's fault, that other witnesses did not see the object land or take off," Dr. Hynek continued. "A movie of this would have been priceless. I feel in my own mind that hoax is ruled out but I should like very much to find a natural explanation, and I ask readers to let me know if any geophysical prospecting or experimentation had been going on in this area." (Dr. Hynek may be addressed at Dearborn Observa-

tory, Evanston, Ill.)

Hynek, chairman of the Department of Astronomy of Northwestern University, said that "as an astronomer, I am only too well aware of the huge distances in space that to me would make it most unlikely that this was a visitation from elsewhere."

He also said that to the best of his knowledge the reported object does not represent any secret Air Force device.

He declared the impressions made by the object are "the only tangible thing," and that is the chief interest in analysis of materials at the site. Dr. Hynek took samples at the site. The military had taken samples earlier. The main thing is to determine if there are foreign particles in the samples.

The red marking on the UFO, as described by Zamora, was an inverted "B" with a bar across it, Hynek reported. He declared no Air Force official had suggested the markings be kept secret and there was nothing classified about it.

The State Police here, sheriff's department, and city police made no attempt to keep any reports on the UFO secret.

After visiting the site, Hynek remarked that he was impressed with what a tourist attraction it had become. He added it was unfortunate the area was not roped off.

Since the reported landing and take-off of the UFO here, many other unidentified flying objects, or "flying saucers," have been reported.

Dr. Hynek said he was always impressed in cases like this with other reports that spring up, many of which come from what

"we can call 'repeaters' who seem to have the singular ability to see flying saucers almost on schedule. This might be called a gross violation of the laws of chance."

All flying saucers exist as reports, Hynek said. He gave this definition of the aerial phenomenon:

"A flying saucer is any aerial object or phenomenon which remains unexplained long enough for someone to report it."

He said he had come at the Air Force's request to get as many facts firsthand as possible "before the incident becomes legend."

The impressions which Hynek called "the only tangible thing" were those apparently made by the four legs of the object as it landed.

Zamora described the object as egg-shaped, and on his first view of it he thought it was an overturned car. He happened on the incident because he believed at first an explosives storage building near the gully had blown up. The noise, however, apparently came from the UFO on landing and later on take-off.

The policeman was an estimated 450 feet away when he first saw the object. Standing beside the UFO, with their backs to him were what appeared to be two small persons in white coveralls. He did not see them when he was 50 feet from the object as it took off and disappeared over Six-Mile Canyon to the west.

Dr. Hynek Feels Zamora's Account Solid

Robert White of Socorro, cattle inspector, who arrived at the site less than half an hour after other police officers got there, was interviewed Wednesday by Hynek. White told a reporter that the tracks were fresh and they had to be made by an object. He said further the two shallow round impressions, left in addition to the four larger ones, were made by a different object than those on which the UFO landed. These two reminded White of a shoe heel. There were no prints within the circles, however. White added these were not any known animal tracks.

White was coming into Socorro from the north when he heard State Police Sgt. Sam Chavez asking State Policeman Ted Jordan by radio to come to the scene. The inspector asked Chavez what the incident was, and the latter then asked White to come there.

Green snakeweed and green greasewood, and clumps of dry grass had been seared by a flame of some kind at the site. Green greasewood does not burn easily.

The incident drew another investigator to Socorro Wednesday. He was Ray Stanford of Phoenix, Ariz., a member of the National Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomena, with headquarters in Washington. He also visited the site and talked with several persons. Stanford said he was not an official investigator for the committee.

2 Objects Sighted At Polvadera, Luis Lopez Recalled

The reported sighting of an unidentified flying object in Socorro shortly before 6 p.m. last Friday prompted Mrs. John H. Cardwell of Luis Lopez Monday to recall two night sightings of strange objects last summer. The sightings were at Luis Lopez and Polvadera.

Mrs. Cardwell and her husband were watching television in their living room at 9 or shortly after on that night when they noticed a brightly-lighted object through the large living room window on the east side. It was a dark, clear night.

The parents and their three children stepped outside to get a better view of the object slowly moving eastward. The object would become extremely bright white light and then dim. The lighted, moving object proceeded slowly eastward, rose and cleared the mountains, which at this point are about six miles directly north of Stallion Site on White Sands Missile Range, Mrs. Cardwell said. The object probably was about a mile away when first sighted.

A month later Mrs. Cardwell mentioned the object to her mother-in-law, Mrs. Olen Cardwell at Polvadera, and learned that the latter also had seen a similar moving object shortly after 10 o'clock at night. This sighting was about a month after the Luis Lopez incident.

The Olen Cardwells had retired for the night, Mrs. John Cardwell recalled. They believed they had turned off all the lights, but Mrs. Cardwell noticed that the kitchen, two rooms and 30 feet from the bedroom, appeared brightly lighted. She found the kitchen light was not on. Looking out the window she saw a brilliantly-lighted object an estimated quarter of a mile away.

It was close to the earth and moving slowly in a half-moon arc, and brightening and dimming, like the object at Luis Lopez. In about 10 minutes, the object disappeared over the mountains to the east.

Mrs. John Cardwell theorized the arc-like motion might account for the brightening and dimming of the object.

Santa Fean Reports Seeing UFO Landed North of Espanola

An unidentified flying object was reported to have landed and taken off near La Madera, north of Espanola, two days following the stop of a UFO in Socorro.

The evidence that Orlando Gallegos of Santa Fe reported was similar to that found in Socorro. He and his family went to visit his father, just north of La Madera, arriving about 12:30 a.m. Sunday.

Gallegos later told State Police he saw the object sitting on the ground in a gravel area when he went outside to chase away horses. He did not approach closer than 200 feet. He noticed a

ring of blue flame erupting from many jets around the bottom of the craft. The jets were noiseless and were turned off while he watched. He saw no persons around the craft which he described as a windowless bright metal, egg-shaped object and as long as a telephone pole, and probably 14 feet in circumference.

No one ventured out of the Gallegos home again during the night. The object was gone in the morning, but the ground was still smoldering.

A team of investigators at Kirtland Air Force Base, Albuquerque, was to visit the scene.

Whether it was the same UFO or another one is unknown, but Undersheriff James Luckie said a tourist told him in a cafe here Sunday night that a low-flying, bright object had nearly crowded him off U.S. 85 two miles south of Socorro between 7:30 and 8 p.m. The unidentified tourist was traveling north of 85, and the object going south.

Mrs. Stull said.

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


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
