


UFO SIGHTINGS PRIOR TO JUNE 24, 1947

by.....LUCIUS FARISH (part two)

Continuing with our record of UFO sightings prior to Kenneth Arnolds' famous sighting, we find the following account.....

In 1916, a sighting was printed in the May 1959 issue of Flying Saucers..... "December 17, 1916 - I saw this morning a most remarkable thing and I believed for the moment that I was suffering from an optical delusion, but as two Sergeant Majors saw it at the same time as myself, I suppose it was there...in the sky. Far away, it appeared like a zeppelin. This rose straight towards the clouds... (in rear of our lines) not like a flying machine, but straight up as a helicopter.After running vertically, it suddenly darted forward at a pace which must have been 200 m.p.h. It then turned around and darted backwards and forwards and then suddenly rising, disappeared in the clouds."

Still another 1916 sighting comes from the January 1956 issue of Fate..... "In 1916, when I was 16, I lived in a small village about 13 miles Northeast of the Ohio River in Southern Ohio. At about 9:00 on a June evening I was sitting under some trees in our yard when I saw what seemed to be a "shooting star" on the northern horizon. It zig-zagged along instead of falling. Fascinated, I watched the curved path it made and to my amazement it came to a stop above a tree about 200 feet across the road from me. It looked like a pale yellow-white moon. At this distance it appeared to be about five feet in diameter. My wonder turned to terror when it advanced slowly toward me. I threw up my hands and said...'NO, NO! STOP!' It stopped at the fence of our yard for a few minutes, then backed up to the tree across the road. Then it rose and finally disappeared. That was not the last I saw of the object..... I went up to my second floor, front bedroom. I had not been in bed long when I saw the object at the

window. I pulled the bedcovers over my head and...do not know how long the light was there."

This is the testimony of a witness who signed only....."B. B."

* NOTE - The beginning of the article should have read as follows.... A 1916 UFO sighting was printed in the May 1959 issue of FS! - Sorry.....eds.

Returning to the letter of Elizabeth Reams in the February 1958 issue of FS., we find the following sighting, "In August 1917 I was lying on the grass resting and gazing into the clear sky, when suddenly to the right of me, I noticed a white cumulus cloud. Where this cloud came from so quickly I'll never know. As I stared at the cloud in amazement a silvery object slowly glided in behind it for protection. It was exactly like the object Dr. Tombaugh saw in New Mexico in 1947. I was certain I saw faces peering at me from the windows as it slipped into the white mist."

The following account by J.P. Alphonse Dupas, was printed in the January 1958 issue of Fate, "In the fall of 1918, my wife and I were invited to supper at the home of friends who lived three and a half miles southwest of us. We had supper with our friends and at 10:00 pm, started out on the trip home. As we took the dead-end road in our wagon, we noticed a small light in the road. I judge it to have been about two miles away, near the dead-end. This ball of light was approaching us swiftly. We had to cross a small bridge over a deep gully, so I pressed my team to avoid meeting what we thought was a car with only one headlight. When we reached the gully the light was illuminating the countryside for nearly half a mile around. As we came up on the other side of the gully, my horses shied and tried to get off the road. We and the horses were blinded by that powerful light. The ball of light stopped about 150 feet from our wagon, and after a moment it receded to where it had come from. We did not hear a sound. I searched the road for tracks with a flashlight, but found only my wagon tracks."

The April 1954 issue of Fate carries the following story by Stanley Clason of Kent, Washington, regarding an unidentified aerial object seen by him.....

"The first time I saw a sky object was about 1920.

I was 10 years-old and living on a homestead in northern Montana. I had been to my uncle's place about three miles from home and was walking across a pasture on my way home. The sky was clear, almost cloudless.

I was watching some curlews flying around when I noticed an object traveling from the northwest to the southeast. It seemed very high and traveling fast. It didn't have the 'wobbling' motion that some of the saucers seem to have. It was a long, slim, pointed shape and appeared silvery in color.

I immediately classified it as a zeppelin, having heard of their use by the Germans in World War I. I told my parents about the object and they said it was a balloon which satisfied me at the time. Now I'm not sure about that.

If my memory is correct, and I remember the object very vividly, it was traveling at least twice or three times as fast as the swept-wing jets that fly around here now."

More early UFO's are reported by C. B. Alves of Seattle, Washington, in the February 1955 issue of Fate.....

"This fall it will be 34 years since I saw four of these mysterious things - - and I will never forget a detail of the awe-inspiring experience. I can place the year accurately as it was only a week or so after Man O' War beat Sir Barton in their 'match' at Devonshire. That was in 1920 and was the only race run by Man O' War that I did not see.

...Three of us had driven from Houston to the Gulf Coast, about 50 miles above Freeport, Texas, to do some fishing. We reached the water about 2 a.m. - Soon I got a fast hit and wrestled in a seven-pound weakie. Busy with the fish, I failed to notice how bright it was getting until I had landed the fish. Then I saw a fast-traveling object heading directly toward me. I yelled to both men to come as quickly as they could but couldn't raise either of them.

When about 100 yards from me, the disc turned south and I noticed three more directly behind that seemed identical with it. The only noticeable difference was in the light emanating from ~~within~~ ~~it~~ - them. (continued...next pge)



The first and last 'disks' showed a brilliant pink, pastel light, and the second and third glowed a pale green that was just as brilliant.

These things looked exactly like two big silver plates set edge to edge, and appeared to be about 25 feet in diameter and some 10 feet thick at the center.

They did not spin as they progressed but sliced through the air at great speed. The disks began climbing when they headed south toward Freeport, and I watched them until they twinkled out in the distance."

Returning again to the April issue of Fate and the letter of William Montgomery of Frazzysburg, Ohio, we find the following sighting.....

"My neighbor, a very reliable person, told me that while at work one day in July, 1921, he saw a bright disk about the size of a wash tub fly directly overhead. It made a screeching noise and frightened his horses so that they nearly got away from him."

Thomas E. Wade of Marfrance, West Virginia, tells of his experience in the May 1957 issue of Fate.....

"In the late summer of 1922, when I was 17 years old, I lived with my family near Wellston, Ohio.


One evening my brother Harry, Charles Holenshead, a friend of ours, and I joined two other boys, Ralph Thorne and Orvil Patten. These two boys were very strong church-goers and wanted us to go somewhere with them and hold a prayer meeting and sing some songs.

About 11:00 - o'clock, as we ended the meeting and started toward our homes, we noticed what appeared to be a bright light far up in the sky. It took on a funnel shape and descended to the earth. Everything became as bright as on a

sunny day, except that the light seemed to have a pinkish glow. The light lasted for about a half hour. Then it began to fade and the funnel rose high in the sky until at last it was a bright ball again. Finally this disappeared, leaving us in darkness."

The November 1957 issue of Flying Saucers contains the following sighting made by John M. Matthews of New York City.....

"This phenomena occurred during the early 1920's between 1923 and 1927. I don't remember the exact date, but I was attending primary school and my father was employed out of town in Ohio and was away except for week-ends and this event occurred during the week. This is the item from the Beaver Falls News Tribune..... On the previous morning at about 2 a.m., railroad workers in the College yards (north end of town) of the P. & L. E. RR (New York Central) happened to notice in the clear night sky a cone shaped object..




It was travelling west from over the Beaver River and the hills eastward of the river and the yards.

When this cone shaped object was almost directly over the yards there was a brilliant flash like a sky rocket, which lighted up the sky, after which the object disappeared. There was no sound of an explosion of any kind.

No explanation was offered!"

GREAT UFO SIGHTINGS OF THE 60's

No. 3 - Tasmania - 1960

There are many people who have scanned the skies for years in the hope that someday, somewhere, they might catch a glimpse of a ship from another world. Had they been in Tasmania at 6:10 p.m. on Oct. 4, 1960, they might have witnessed what was truly one of the great UFO sightings of the 60's.

On that date, Rev. Lionel Browning, an Anglican minister, and Mrs. Browning, observed a great cigar-shaped spaceship accompanied by five flying saucers.

The Rev. Browning, in describing the experience, said " There was definitely a mother ship and five discs. First, we saw a large, dull-grey craft about 300 feet long. It came at plane-stalling speed and seemed to pause. Then out of the clouds above and behind the ship, five small discs came shooting at terrific speed."

The mother ship was completely noiseless and had four vertical bands. He described the discs as being approximately 30 feet across and flat underneath with a dome on top.

After remaining in view for two minutes, the huge ship and the five discs reversed their course and disappeared in the clouds. Two hrs. later, loud atmospheric explosions were heard in the area. Truly, this was one of the " Great UFO Sightings of the 60's!"

THE BRAIN BEHIND APOLLO

Four days after the first site at Thule, Greenland, came into operation, Holmes (Dyer Brainerd - Holmes) found in a dramatic way that the radar was working....

better than expected! - - - There was an emergency, middle-of-the-night call from the Colorado Headquarters of the Air Defense Command.

The lower of the two Thule radar fans had turned up all sorts of "targets" and the alarm had been instantly flashed to Colorado. Holmes, asleep in Moorestown, was awakened by an aide assigned to the defense command.

The aide hinted: because the matter was highly secret - at what happened - and hinted that he thought the "targets" were just reflections from the rising moon.

Holmes was cool, as he usually is under pressure. He pondered and quickly he - hoor. / AGREED.

And so it was. But the phone calls continued for two hours more.

!!!!!! End of Article ??????

There you have it! - And there we've had it also! - How many times did we read this article before it stuck us? - We dunno, but here is a controversy with plenty of meat.....

First of all...it was supposed to be a big hush hush secret! - How did it get in the newspapers then.....?

Secondly...The aide hinted that it was the rising moon.....Why did he hint at such a thing.....?

Thirdly...Holmes agreed! - Awakened out of a sound sleep, maybe we would too! --But not to the press...hush hush!!

Fourthly...It was night-time in Moorestown.....Was it night-time in Greenland also??

Fifth... Somebody must have drunk it... because the calls continued for two more hours! - - - - SO - Who was calling and where from? - Was intelligent life trying to contact us? - Why were people calling...they can't tune in on radar can they??? - To report what? - SAUCERS of course! - What else? - How did the newspapers get hold of this? - Must have been the dissatisfied callers! -

Well.....You read the newspaper article (in CPB Files) we printed for your - theory about a Controversial Phenomena!

Someone slipped somewhere! - Was it the aide? - The callers? - or - (brainy) Brainerd(sherlock) Holmes?

Dear Mr. Ferriere:

I imagine that by this time you have given me up for lost, but, at long last, here is the piece that I promised you.

He is a good egg, and he might be just adventuresome enough to go for the idea. I have no doubts that the series would sell papers.

I am also enclosing my \$2 for a subscription to your magazine, and I am looking forward to meeting the rest of your group.

.....Thirteen years is a long time for a person to remain "underground", but, due to public opinion and the nature of my profession, I have been forced to do so.....until relatively recently.

.....For these thirteen years I have been an active newspaperman, editor, reporter, photographer, and feature writer., but the very nature of my off-hours interests forced me to remain quiet about them for fear that the unveiling of such interests would endanger my position in various communities in which I resided and worked, and also in my church work.

.....The sowing of the seeds of this interest occured in the summer of 1951. I was completing the requirements for my Master's Degree at a New England University, and like most students in the same circumstances was trying to conserve what funds I had for use, within a few weeks, when I was to be thrown out into the cold world of business and the glum task of earning a living.

.....Single at the time, I still welcomed the opportunity to take a girl out for an evening of movies, concert, lecture, or just a hamburger and some conversation.


.....A note on the college bulletin boards announced an off-campus lecture by a European who claimed to have been "there" in the space ship of an alien planet. Admission was only fifty cents, so I took a friend...just for laughs.

.....We were not disappointed. The lecturer had an interpreter - he could not speak English during his talk - only before and after. He was quite striking in his appearance, striving for the look of a learned intellectual, but not quite making it.

.....His reasons for his being chosen for the trip by the aliens were that he was without sin, did not eat meat or fish, did not swat flies, had never gone with women, and in general, was quite pure.

....."They" chose him because he alone could warn civilization, especially - those in power in this country, that the world was heading for something that would cause Sodom and Gamorrah to resemble a Sunday school picnic.

.....He appeared quite serious and sincere in his manner, giving vague descriptions of "those" who sought him - of course, "they" ~~was~~ beautiful creatures, tall, learned, having perfected mind reading, teleportation, and all of the other tricks of the heros of the science-fiction novels, to the - Nth - degree.

.....He drew diagrams of the space - ships (not saucers, but, Buck Rogers-style with big stern rockets) and told of the degree of perfection of "their" civilization. "They" took him to view planets which had not heeded "their" warning - these were a mass of cinders. The inhabitants of those who did heed were living in the lap of -- luxury.

.....The entire pitch turned out to be a religious one, with only one particular group to be "saved." Those who heeded his word.

.....The secondary pitch was the selling of two books, one telling of his trip and marvelous adventures, and the

other, a handbook which revealed the sections of the Bible to be read and followed - and - those to be shunned.

.....My date and myself were both disappointed in the ultimate point of the whole thing, and neither of us parted with further cash for either of the volumes, both printed in Europe, but in English.

.....We were, however, impressed by the number of earnest, sincere people - students, professors, and members of the community in general - more than a hundred of them - who responded to the small announcements and crowded into the small hall in search of enlightenment.

.....The incident was forgotten for a few months, until I had settled into an editorial post on a small town weekly newspaper. With plenty of spare time, I started reading everything on the subject of space-travel, contacts, sightings, strange disappearances, and stranger findings, which I could lay my hands upon.

.....I interested a friend, who some months before had been in an open air theater near Boston which had been - - observed by a UFO. He said that he had called several newspapers, trying for the bounty paid on newstips, but that no mention of the sighting appeared in print.

.....From my previous readings on the subject of UFO's I had gathered what I considered enough knowledge to enable me to question him in an objective manner on the subject. I am still convinced that what he saw was nothing which could be explained away in terms of weather balloons, air inversions, lights, Venus, conventional aircraft, comets or the imagination. I never doubted his truthfulness nor that of the others who were with him at the theater.

.....I gave him the names and addresses of various fan magazines and he subscribed to some of these. Before long his name was on many "sucker" mailing lists and he was branded as somewhat of a kook due to his supposed off-beat interests. I did not subscribe to them.

.....In this small community I came upon two other family groups who had sighting experiences. Neither group were noted as being fanciful or fanatics of any sort, but both had experiences which had caused them fear and near hysteria.

.....One young newly married couple were on their front porch on the Main street of town in the summer of 1956.....

Looking up over the house across the street they saw what at first appeared to be an advertising balloon of a type which was in use at the time to herald the opening of super markets. Watching it they observed it move in such a rapid manner that it seemed to disappear at one point and reappear some distance away. The distance traveled was so great that the object (which they described as being flatish and round) seemed to change size. They noted that at times it varied in size from that of a silver dollar held at arm's length to that of a manhole cover at the same range. They said that motorists stopped and joined them in their observation. They claimed that they had read of no UFO accounts previously, and were both of such a fine character that I had no reason to doubt them.

.....The other sighting was by the wife and son of a newspaper employee. He made a hurried trip home from his office one night following a frantic phone call from his wife that something had been hovering over their back yard. Arriving home he found both she and their son in tears. Piecing together her story he found that they had been cleaning up the evening supper dishes when, looking out the kitchen window, they had both seen a luminescent disc-shaped object hovering over the trees at the rear of their land about 300 feet from the house. It just hovered, they told him, and it rose and disappeared into the evening sky, the sighting occurring just after sunset..... but in the East. He then phoned the information to his paper, but nothing..... appeared in print.

.....Persons learning of my interest in the matter, which is shared by my wife, have sent me many third and fourth hand reports of sightings. But due to the fact that I have been "underground", these have been delayed, and in some cases those making the sightings have moved from the area, making first hand questioning impossible or, at least, impractical.

.....Now, I am convinced, is the time for myself, and the countless others all over the country who have been - "underground" to come out into the day light and share whatever light we may have with others.

.....It has been rumored that the Air Force is in possession of great quantities of knowledge and data about UFO's. This storehouse of knowledge, I believe, can be duplicated, if those of the non-military segment of our society are encouraged to talk about their sighting.

.....The only way to give a note of -- respectability to these persons who have something to report is for those who share an interest in the study of UFO's and other branches of the forbidden aspects of science to make themselves known. There is strength in numbers.



.....Let us form a group for study or join one already formed. I believe that those of us who pursue this "science" now will be in on the ground floor when discoveries are made within the next few years. By studying the theories behind the ideas that we are not alone in this universe we, who are interested in the matter, will not be caught as flatfooted as the rest when our trips into space reveal things which we may not have even guessed at as yet.

Undersea Saucer to Probe Ocean Mysteries



Since the beginning of mankind, the sea has been a constant source of wonderment to the enquiring mind of man.

(Lest We Forget...Illustration above shows undersea flying saucer craft approaching a sunken ship lying at the base of an underwater mountain range. - It is a revolutionary new concept for a deep diving vehicle which has been conceived by Lockheed Missiles & Space Co.)

.....Strangely enough, man today knows more about the surface of the Moon than the bottom of the sea. And, while it may be argued that too much time and money is being expended on the space effort, it is encouraging to see that, at long last, man is now undertaking the first steps to probe the long neglected mysteries of the sea!!

In May, of this year, a French scientist, Pierre Drach, made a dive of 27,510 feet in the French-built bathyscaph, Archimede. Drach went down to the bottom of the Puerto Rico Trench, the deepest spot in the Atlantic. The Trench, located 100 miles north of San Juan, is more than twice as long as Arizona's Grand Canyon and five times as deep.

Drach, upon surfacing, expressed true surprise at the extent of life (marine) five miles down. "The Trench," he said, "is relatively full of things. I saw fish from one to five inches long swimming past the Archimede's portholes!"

Scientists conducted a four month study of the Trench this summer to collect rock and sediment samples, study properties, temperatures and salinity of the water and the transmission of sound, as well as taking photographs.

Vast amounts of copper, manganese and nickel lie at the bottom of the sea. Dr. John L. Mero at the Institute of Marine Resources, University of California, feels that to retrieve these valuable metals from the ocean floor may be more economical than mining them on land. He suggests that a hydraulic dredge mounted on a specially equipped ship could sweep up the metals.

"UNDERSEA SAUCER TO PROBE OCEAN MYSTERIES"- cont.

Admiral Denys W. Knoll, a Navy oceanographer, stated recently that ocean research promises "fantastic gains" for the U.S. military posture as well as important benefits to the national and world economies. "Until we learn to understand and exploit ocean space," he said, "we will have many deficiencies in our over-all military posture. I feel this area requires the highest priority for the nations' welfare and the peace and welfare of the world."

According to Knoll, the Navy is making some progress but needs, "new techniques and new imagination because there is a lack of fundamental knowledge and necessary techniques for exploiting the oceans." He also stressed most urgently the need for the development of submersibles - capable of supporting human life at great depths.

"SAUCER IS ANSWER"

A revolutionary approach has been made toward the development of such a vehicle. It has been conceived by - scientists and engineers at Lockheed in Sunnydale, California. The vehicle has the appearance of an undersea - flying saucer. The lenticular, or lens shaped submersible is designed to peer at and probe the ocean bottom. Dubbed the "Turtle", a model has been tested and the tests have proven that the "saucer" is hydrodynamically efficient and controllable. This imaginative and fertile concept was put forth by Dr. Willy Fiedler who played a major role in Lockheed's development and proving of the Navy's submarine - launched Polaris missile.

"THE 'TURTLE' & TRIESTE"

In discussing the undersea saucer, (Turtle) Fiedler stated: "Exploration of the ocean's bottom for scientific, economic and military purposes has been limited up to now - largely because of the lack of a versatile underwater vehicle capable of operating in this environment." He also stressed that as airplanes differ in shape from - dirigibles or airships - so might vehicles designed to explore the ocean bottoms differ from conventional submarine shapes.

"While some submergence vehicles, such as the Navy's Trieste, have gone to the greatest of depths-the big need is a vehicle of greater volume, maneuverability, endurance, ruggedness, independence from surface ships, and - with broader depth capabilities."

He added....."While self-propulsion is important, there is no need for high speed in most Turtle uses. The smaller types would be battery-powered, and the larger - by nuclear propulsion."

"TURTLE ADVANTAGES"

Among the many and varied potential uses for an undersea saucer as outlined by Dr. Fiedler are:....A search and rescue vessel for disabled submarines,a mobile and virtually undetectable long-range sonar outpost,a - missile-launching platform reaching to every door of most nations,salvage and recovery of cargoes from sunken ships and the laying,....inspecting and repairing of communications cables beneath turbulent seas or even ice, andof course,.....an undersea base for the mining of minerals and the acquiring of food to meet the needs of the growing world population.

"INNER VS. OUTER SPACE"

In concluding, Fiedler said "Habitability and comfort are of prime importance in operating any submersible, and the Turtle would offer accommodations like a small apartment rather than the crowded spaces of submersibles built to date."

Strange though it be, man's attempts to reach the stars came before these most important attempts to explore "inner - space."

It is quite likely that the answers to many mysteries both past and present, will be discovered right here, in our "own backyard."

And.....will it stumble upon other mysterious underwater craft which have been so often reported? Possibly.....an underwater city of sorts? Or.....an actual "saucer base" at the bottom of the sea?



...Her husband, rifle in hand, came running., but by the time he got there, the big thing was swimming parallel to the shore at a very fast speed.


The three Ziglers were sure that what they saw was not floating logs. It definitely was a live animal, they insist.

THE MAN WHO RODE THE THUNDER

July 26, 1959... Travelling close to the speed of sound at an altitude of 47,000 feet, Lt. Rankin was forced to bail out of his F8U Crusader jet without special pressure equipment when his ship caught fire.

After dropping seven miles in free - fall, he plunged into the grip of a violent storm.

A four-engined Lancaster bomber landed at a South Wales aerodrome, badly damaged and engine cowlings missing. There were only four men aboard as they landed. Three of them had bailed out.

Two of the men were found that same night some thirty miles away in the hills. The third man had completely disappeared! The missing man was a Welshman whose home town was not more than fifty miles away.

All this happened about December the 1st., 1944.

On the 21st of December, a doctor was called to a neighboring town to take care of a dead airman, found by - farmers. The doctor had gone with two other Air Force medics to look over the corpse.

They found the body at the feet of a ravine about 25 feet deep.

On top of the bluff they found a single set of footprints leading to the cliff.

The first and only snow of the season thus far had fallen two days previously. All three doctors were satisfied that the man had not been dead more than twenty-four hours.

The jaw-bone had been broken but had begun to heal, so it was thought that this had happened when he bailed out. The neck and one arm had been broken, apparently when he fell into the ravine. He had been shaved within the last 24 hours before his death!

A careful investigation was started, covering a radius of fifty miles.

No one had seen the injured man. No one had offered food or shelter to any stranger.

The airman was still in his flying suit and had no kit of any sort and no provisions.

He was tossed about in this storm of rain, hail, thunder and lightning for over a half hour., yet.....he lived to write a book about it!

The book is titled.....

"The Man Who Rode The Thunder"

by - Lt. Colonel William H. Rankin
of the USMC.

At length they found deep footprints in some soft ground where he had landed, not one hundred yards from a farmhouse and about one hundred feet from a well-travelled road.

His parachute was neatly folded at the foot of a stone wall.

The farmer had seen or heard nothing of the airman.

Amnesia? - Probably, but where did he get food to survive three weeks of bitter cold, damp Welsh winter?

How was he able to shave within the last 24 hours without a razor?

Why would anyone hide him and refuse to admit it?

Airmen carry no valuables or money; where had he been for those past three weeks?

Nothing was ever brought to light... which could solve this mystery!

Planes continue to disappear and or crash mysteriously even though some of the causes have been found.

Sometimes it is never found.....!



THE HOLLOW EARTH???

Dr. Raymond Bernard, noted scholar and author of "The Hollow Earth", says that the true home of the "flying saucers", is a huge underground world whose entrance is at the North Pole.

In the hollow interior of the earth lives a super race which wants nothing to do with man on the surface.

They launched their flying saucers only after man threatened the world with A-bombs.

9/10/64 - West Brattleboro, Vermont - - Sandy Daszuta of West Boylston, Mass., was terrified by a UFO that landed near a field in Brattleboro.

There was a white light revolving on the inside of the pearl-colored ufo and it took off very fast.

It left imprints in the ground which were still there a week later.

9/10/64 - Massachusetts.....One night, 2 or 3 weeks ago, a UFO the size of a soup plate was observed by Joy Castagnetti over Mt. Wachusett.

A ufo flap was reported to have occurred near the Worcester Airport about that time. (credit - Sam Reynolds)

7/?/64 - Plainview, New York..... In the latter part of July, Mr. Gary Kopf and about 20 other persons who were attending an out-door party, saw three mysterious objects travel overhead.

The time was about 10:30 p.m., clear and cool. The objects appeared to be high in the sky. Sometimes they were stationary and at other times moved rapidly. The objects, about the size of the stars, appeared to be round., but through field glasses looked to be oval-shaped and of a whitish color. No noise was heard.

The first object moved from north to south. (a steady light.) The second one was blinking rapidly and moved from north-west to south-east. (both of these objects moved from horizon to horizon.)

.....One morning not long ago Feature Parade Photographer, Edward A. Cournoyer took off from Worcester Municipal Airport in a Beechcraft "Musketeer" for a local flight.

Ed, who was alone, expected nothing unusual: ground temperature was 24 degrees and there was an overcast ceiling with some haze, but he had flown in much worse weather.

He climbed to 2,500 feet and pointed his aircraft north. Flying above Holden, he looked at the horizon ahead and made a double-take. Sailing gradly across the earth behind Knobby Mt. Wachusett was a great aircraft carrier. It was right where he had expected to see the rugged silhouette of Mt. Monadnock.

While still trying to puzzle out the phenomenon, he overheard a radio call to the Worcester Airport Tower from an aircraft above Westboro. -Could anyone else see the mirage, the other pilot demanded. -Ed hastened to radio that he could.

When he climbed another 500 feet, the illusion disappeared and Monadnock looked like her old self.

Here's Ed's explanation.....

"I was looking at Mt. Monadnock through a 50-mile-long layer of compressed warm air. The warm air acted like a lens, so that the image of the mountain was reversed when it reached my eye.

The bottom of the mountain had been flipped up across the cone to give the impression of a flat-top.

It was one of those tricks of nature.... one that I will never forget!"



It started on Sept. the 7th. 1964
.....when on the late news (TV)
a film of a crater was shown which
was believed to have been formed
by a mysterious red object.

A large crater with three smaller holes were found in Glasboro, New Jersey.

The news analyst went on to say that 'metal' was found in the large crater.
During the next few days many people told me of seeing the news film, but they,



It has been reported that the Unidentified Flying Object Commission in Washington sent a team of investigators to the scene and declared "a flying object has landed here."



Big Ear Tuned On Outer Space?

If tiny spacecraft were sent by unknown "Lilliput" planets to probe our world, they would be spotted by a huge radio antenna in Massachusetts built of Alcoa

aluminum, which can detect a quarter-inch metal sphere 1000 miles in space.

Constructed to an unprecedented degree of accuracy, the 120-foot aluminum saucer, installed on Haystack Hill at Tyngsboro, Mass., is considered the Free World's most advanced radio communications instrument of its kind. It is part of "Project Haystack," which includes, among its tasks, finding needles in the biggest haystack in the universe, outer space.

Designed and built by North American Aviation, Inc., for the Electronic Systems Division of the Air Force Systems Command, it will be operated for the U. S. Air Force by Massachusetts Institute of Technology-Lincoln Laboratory. Approximately 350,000 pounds of metal supplied by Aluminum Company of America were required to construct the big dish and its protective radome.

For protection from New England's famed weather, the Haystack antenna is enclosed in a giant radome measuring 150 feet across at its widest part. The radome frame, at first glance resembling an undisciplined interlacing of structural members, is a network of 930 carefully spaced triangles formed from 200,000 pounds of extruded aluminum beams.

The arrangement of the triangular openings permits efficient passage of radio signals. The aluminum frame supports a fiberglass skin, forming a weather-tight enclosure capable of withstanding winds up to 130 miles per hour.

The antenna performs two tasks: It must collect and focus radio frequency energy, as an optical telescope does with light, and it must hit a target with an R.F. signal, by transmitting a tight concentrated beam, as does a well-focused searchlight. First assignment of the mammoth research tool will be to expand communications experiments now being conducted by 60-foot diameter antennas aimed toward a belt of copper space fibers, tiny "dipole" satellites recently placed in orbit by the United States.

Scientists Fail to Find Meteorite

SEQUOIA NATIONAL PARK, Calif. (AP) — A scientific team spent another fruitless day in their search for a meteorite which blazed across the sky Sept. 3, before crashing to earth in a remote region of Sequoia National Park.

The team of Griffith Park Observatory staff members, headed by Ronald Oriti, is racing the clock, hoping to find some fragments of the celestial body before minerals and water contaminate them.

Scientists reported they doubt the meteorite, which looked like a brilliant magnesium flare, could have survived impact with the earth intact. Several campers in the park told of hearing explosions on the night the object was sighted.

Ozarkers, Pilots Spot Strange Lights in Sky

9/8/64 - Did one, or two, meteorites flash across Missouri skies last night?

The question arose today as reports came in concerning the sighting of eerie lights over the state.

Richard O. Wheeler, air traffic controller in the FAA tower at Municipal Airport here, said the meteorite was seen both from the air and the ground. He said he and another controller, James Schultes, saw the object, consisting mainly of a searing blue tail, about 9 p.m. as they were looking to the northeast.

A Delta Air Lines pilot, who arrived from Little Rock at 9:15, said he saw what he thought was a meteorite when he was south of Springfield. He said it disappeared to the northeast.

An Ozark Air Lines pilot,

inbound from St. Louis, said when he landed here at 9:50 that he saw the presumed meteorite when he was in the vicinity of Vichy about 9 p.m. and it was north-east of there.

But state troopers in the northern half of Missouri reported seeing the flash about 9:20 p.m. Reports came from Jefferson City, St. Joseph, St. Louis, Macon, and Lee's Summit.

The first call to the FAA tower here came from a motorist who thought a jet plane was on fire.

The Greene County sheriff office also had calls from sheriff's departments in Hickory and St. Clair counties, but a check assured that no aircraft were in trouble.

A pilot and passengers of a private plane also saw the flash about 9 p.m. (credit - Ray Copenhaver)


HUNT'S ON FOR SHOOTING STAR
Calif. 9/8/64 - Scientists are racing the clock in a hunt for a meteorite that blazed into the earth's atmosphere from space last Thursday. The shooting star was tracked to Sequoia Park's Hockett Meadows, at the 7,000-foot level, by a Griffith Park observatory scientist.

He is Ronald Oriti, who said if the meteorite or its fragments are found now it could yield valuable data about space, such as meteorite age, fossils and space organisms.

If not found quickly, he said, water and earth minerals will have a chance to contaminate the celestial visitor. If found, scientists said, the meteorite would be the first one observed to actually be recovered.

Strange Going-on Over Floral Park - Long Island, New York...by...James Krazowski, C P B Representative.

It all started when a good friend of mine, Richard Walbroehl, came up to me and told of his sighting that he saw on August 1st 1964.....

It was about 5:00 p.m., when he saw a cup and saucer effect acting strangely in the sky. This phenomena, which he says he saw plainly, lasted for about five minutes and ended suddenly when a plane seemed to come parallel to it. Richie said, and I quote...,"all of a sudden it disappeared alongside of the plane." It was moving N.W. to S.E.

Floral Park - 8/3/64

Michael MacNalley, noted for his humor and honesty, said he spotted an object in the sky about 4:30 p.m. Mike said the object acted strangely for about 30 seconds., he described it as a bright oval-shaped disc.

Floral Park - 8/5/64

I, James Krazowski, while swimming in the town swimming pool, saw a bright object which seemed to leap from cloud to cloud. It was moving at a tremendous speed. No sound was involved. It was about 4:30 p.m. It was approximately 800 feet from where Michael MacNalley had stood when he had his sighting.

Floral Park - 8/6/64

9:15 p.m. - A group of boys, and I, were sitting on a wall of an underpass, when we spotted a strange light in the sky. The object was moving erratically until it reached a bright star (?) which then appeared to make an L-shaped pattern in the form of a capital L. After doing this, the object disappeared.

Floral Park - 8/7/64

9:20 p.m. - Object again sighted by many people. Made L-shaped pattern, then it disappeared. This sighting went on from August 6th to August 13th., between the hours of 9:15 - 9:30 p.m.

The Big Sighting

8/25/64 - 7:40 p.m. - A fireball was spotted N.W. of the Floral Park football field. It was huge and bright at first, but within a period of three minutes, it simmered down to a small bright oval-shaped object. This sighting lasted almost 15 minutes!

Although each sighting seems different, I covered each story, these factors are apparent.....

Factors

- 1 - Each object, at one time or another, was described as bright oval-shaped.
- 2 - Each object was moving from the N.W. to the South-east.
- 3 - 80% of the sightings were described as making a capital L in the sky.
- 4 - All took place over Floral Park after 4:00 p.m. and before 9:30 p.m.

Mystery Explosion Jolts New Jersey Area
A large mysterious boom was heard over a wide area in the Delaware Valley about 2:30 p.m., on October 9th 1964.

It startled hundreds of residents, who said it sounded "like an explosion."

Police departments were flooded with telephone calls and the Camden Police and Fire Departments said it received more than 50 calls from Pennsauken, Collingwood, Haddonfield, Bellmawr, Haddon Heights, and Camden.

One of the Camden calls was from the Philadelphia fire department. The caller said he had received word "there was an explosion at the New York shipbuilding Corp., yards, and did Camden need any assistance?"

He was promptly assured there was no explosion in Camden.

Radio Beams Hint Life on Two Planets

The unusual nature of the radio spectra of these sources was noted last year by an Anglo-American team of radio astronomers.

In a 1964 conference in the United States, called by the Space Science Board of the National Academy of Sciences the subject was discussed, and there was also an attempt by the National Radio Astronomy Observatory to intercept signals from planets orbiting two nearby stars.

----- CTA-2I, & CTA-I02 ---- The two objects reported by Nikolai S. Kardashev are known by their catalogue no's in the Heanently Radio Sources prepared by the California Institute of Technology.



A Soviet astronomer has suggested that two pinpoint sources of powerful radio emission in the constelations Aries and Pegasus may be the beacons of super civilizations.

SPECTRA UNIQUE

From a search of prints in the Palomar Sky Survey, the two sources of radio energy seem to be optically invisible.

Above all, the spectra of their emissions is unlike that of any other sources recorded. Both peak intensities are at about 900 megacycles.

As noted by Kardashev, this happened to be close to the optimum frequency for interstellar communication. The optimum frequency range is bounded on each side by a form of radio interference.

In one case it is background radio 'noise' that originates naturally in the universe. (cosmic noise) In the other it is a form of receiver noise produced by the inherent properties of radio waves. (quantum noise) The combined noise from these two effects reaches a minimum near 900 megacycles.

PLOTS CURVE

Taking these effects into consideration, Kardashev has plotted a curve representing the ideal radio spectrum for communication between civilizations.

He finds that it bears a very striking resemblance to the spectra of CTA-2I and CTA-I02.

His proposal is rooted in the idea by prof. Shklovsky that a highly advanced civilization would seek to draw attention to itself with extraordinary and powerful radio beacons.

Since radio waves move at the speed of light, an exchange of messages with a civilization 500 light years away would take 1,000 years.

- The Deseret News and law enforcement agencies were deluged with calls Friday night and early Saturday, about unidentified objects seen over south-east Salt Lake City about 3:30 p.m., Friday.

An unidentified woman said she saw the objects as she was doing her laundry.

Her description was essentially the same as that given by many

other observers: "They were white and disc-shaped."

She said she watched them through binoculars as they flew out of sight beyond Mt. Olympus.

"I didn't know what to think when I looked into the binoculars," said - Thomas McLelland, 14-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Kent C. McLelland.

TWO OF THEM

"Frankly, I was scared. There were two of them and they definitely looked like saucers, with the bottoms rounded and the tops not so rounded.

"I saw them fly north and east and follow the contour of Mt. Olympus until they disappeared into the trees." He said he kept watching the area but they had not reappeared by 4:40 p.m.

Lee Sjoblom, 12, son of Mr. and Mrs. Paul Sjoblom, also described the objects as "white and disc-shaped." They rendezvoused over Mt. Olympus and Mill-creek Canyon area, he said.

SOME DIFFER

A few descriptions differed from the majority.....

One woman, a resident of the east bench, said "one was orangish-red and one was silver. Both were shaped like eggs."

One boy said there was only one object and it was round-shaped with a dome on top, while Leon Ottley, 15, son of Mr. and Mrs. Eldon E. Ottley, saw the object as a "platform with four boxes on it. It was white or silver and was in the vicinity of Mt. Olympus."

His brother, however, described the object as "three balloons clumped together."

The Federal Aviation Agency, when asked about the sightings by the Deseret News, said..... "We're discounting the reports. None of our towers spotted anything and no weather balloons were up at that time," a spokesman said.

GAS BALLOONS-?

"Of course there is the possibility that a gas station or some other business has released some gas-filled balloons," he suggested.

Whatever the objects were, balloons or inter-stellar buggies, it's plain that old flying saucer reports never die, they just fade away - and then come back again.

As Julia Tennant, 11, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. J. Max Tennant, said.....

"It seemed to fade away and come back, fade away and come back. I never saw anything like it."

Now THAT most people can believe.

Gloucester, Mass. (10/26/64) - Six crewmen were rescued Sunday after their 105-foot fishing dragger hit a submerged object and sank off East Point Light off Cape Ann. The crewmen managed to lower dories before the Olympia sank in 300 feet of water. They were picked up by another dragger, St. Peter III.

Thomas P. Scola, 43, skipper of the - Olympia, said "We barely had time to throw the dories over before the vessel sank."
