




.....After the object left the area, the two men jumped back into the car (which started promptly they said) and drove home.


While on their way home, the two men noticed something that had completely escaped their attention while they were excitedly watching the strange "egg-shaped" object.

(if this was a case of "spots" before the eyes, then they must have been - "sun spots", and a mighty long way from home at that! - Ole Sol a Mio.....)




If these UFO's really do come from the 'Outer Limits', space, travelling at great speed, then it follows that upon entering the earth's upper atmosphere a great amount of heat is applied to the craft, causing it to glow with intense light.

The same principle applies to earth satellites and meteors and possibly the mysterious green fireballs which no one has ever found a trace of., not even a tiny fragment!

.....or particle.....!

.....Upon entering into the lower atmosphere (especially when hovering or just landed) the UFO would begin to go through a "cooling off" period, at which time the heat accumulated during the entry phase would slowly be discharged. This is, in itself, "enough to keep" of a reason to keep a safe distance!!



The theory has also been advanced that the UFO's may utilize an electro-magnetic form of propulsion, as theorized by many researchers in the saucer field, in which case a person advancing too close to a ufo might come into contact with a magnetic force-field which could cause shock and paralysis., along with other undesirable effects.

To illustrate the seriousness of this matter, let us consider the following statement.....

In November of 1957, the Danish newspaper, B-T, printed a statement by the Danish Air Force Officer, Lt. Col. H.C. Peterson. This is what he had to say about approaching UFO's.....

"Stop at about 150 feet from the craft, and spread out the arms in a friendly manner.

It is not necessary to speak, but think seriously in friendly terms.

Never attempt to shoot at these objects or show war-like intentions."

(a word to the wise should be enough!)

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
Major L. F. Baker, USAF.....

"They were circular, shiny like spun aluminum. They changed course instantaneously."

He witnessed this along with other Air Force witnesses, he said!

To continue with our sightings of strange objects in the sky, we proceed with the account of my personal friend - Mrs. Mildred M. Higgins of Fayetteville, Ark.

(continued from issue # 6) - Suddenly....., the 'red star' came to a halt. We stood amazed, wondering what next. Then, to our complete consternation, it travelled in three small circles...as though someone were writing small - e's, only from right to left. Prof. and I figured out five or six reasons on the spot why it was not a plane, then we made a dash for the key to the observatory which was in possession of the President of the Society. By the time we awakened him, and obtained the key and started on our way, we had lost sight of the object., this was the end of our strange sighting.

Next day, Prof. checked with the army to see if any weather balloons had been released in the surrounding area. None had. - Incidentally, the red color was rather an orange red, like the lighted end of a cigarette. In observing the object I did not feel that this was a light on some dark object, but rather that the entire object was that color.

From the beginning I was impressed that the thing was very, very far away. Had it been a plane we should have heard the motor, with its running light appearing that large, on such a still night. Neither do planes suddenly stop and then - proceed in tiny circles."

From the pages of the UFO REPORTER, NO.- 2, a confidential saucer bulletin edited by the late M. K. Jessup, comes this report from Mrs. Dorothy Morrison of Coral Gables, Florida.....

"On June 11th 1937, at 11:15 p.m., Mrs. Morrison was at Hinglands, No. Carolina. She was staying at a country home near the town, in mountainous country. At a point some 25 or 26 degree above the horizon, and approximately SE by S, she saw a brilliant white light, which remained stationary for about eight minutes, and then...it suddenly went out. Just disappeared. (over - )

## UFO Sightings Prior To June 1947

by - Lucius Farish

It could not have gone behind a mountain, she says, for it was not moving. Compared to a full moon it was about one-sixth the diameter of the moon, which makes it of about 5' apparent diameter. It was not near to her point of observation, and therefore must have been quite large in actual size. That means that if it was ten miles away, it was about 1/10th mile or possibly 500 feet in diameter. It was not a planet."

\*\*\*\*\*

Mrs. E.M.P. of Larkspur, California, relates the following in the pages of the May 1958 issue of Flying Saucers.....

"About 1939, we took our daughters skiing up to Chinook Pass. We lived in Yakima, Washington. It was a beautiful clear, warm day in May and the view of the surrounding mountains, including Mt. Rainier, was absolutely perfect. I love the mountains and so always watch them very closely. This day I was watching Mt. Rainier and there around the top were 7 round balls; that is the way they looked.

They were absolutely motionless and I continued to watch them for about 15 minutes or more. Someone called to me and I turned my head. When I looked back again - they were gone. Now that so many things have come out about the saucers, I am sure that is what I saw at that time, but didn't know it."

\*\*\*\*\*

Next, we find the following sighting in the pages of the June 1953 issue of Fate, related by Rose W. Bushnell of S. Fork, California.....

"In the fall of 1940, my brother David and I were enroute to our camp on Wilder Ridge, after a week-end spent at home. It was about 12:30 on a clear night, with a first quarter moon in the sky. When we neared the top of the mountain our attention was suddenly drawn to a bright object about the size of a baseball which hung high above the horizon. Even as we looked, it changed shape.

I stopped the car and we watched the changes which were evenly spaced and very exciting. The round white ball changed swiftly into a long white bar, then it changed into a beautiful white Christmas tree. Now it took the form of a bell and from this it changed back into the round

white ball, with five little white balls, about the size of golf balls, around it. Next it formed a half-circle and then changed into the first quarter moon, but with bow up and points down.

It kept moving until it righted itself to its proper position in the sky, at which point no further changes took place. This sky phenomena appeared in the east and lasted for approximately 36 seconds. The pictures changed so quickly that there was no pause between them. Each time they formed a perfect picture and then immediately changed into another."

\*\*\*\*\*

Another early sighting comes to light with the following letter published in the August 1960 issue of Flying Saucers.....George Wissemann of North Fork, in California, says.....

"In the summer of 1941, when I was 12 years old, I saw what I know now was no doubt a space ship or a flying saucer. It was in June. We lived in the Sierra Nevada mountains at the time. My dad mined gold for the few meager dollars he managed to scrape together to buy us food.

The first time I saw the strange object was when I was walking up from a fishing trip with my uncle Cort. It looked round and big as the sun as it comes over the mountain. It was resting on a large clearing across the San Joaquin River on Kaiser mountain. The object appeared to be at least 500 feet in diameter.

It was a brilliant, silvery-white. It would shimmer as if it were quicksilver at times. My uncle Cort said it looked like the sun and laughed about it. Dad saw it later too. He said it might be some sort of a tent. No one paid much attention to it but me. I watched most every day until it went away and never did come back. It stayed in the same spot in the clearing near the top of the mountain for nearly 2 weeks. One morning my brother Don came running in from the outside and said a big white thing as big as the moon was flying over Shut-eye (a big mountain). I went outside to see if the huge disc was still on the mountain, but it was gone."

## UFO Sightings Prior to 1947 - by - Lu Farish

(\*editors note- page 3 should have read...continued from issue 7., not #6...sorry)

Once again, we return to the letter of Mrs. E.M.P. of Larkspur, California, printed in the May 1958 issue of Flying Saucers.....

"Then again in 1942, I was in the back yard preparing to go inside when my attention was attracted to the plane that was coming from Seattle. They made a wide circuit into the airport. I saw the plane and all of a sudden another one popped up and came directly toward me, going like the wind. It passed directly over the house and could not have been up more than 1500 feet. It seemed to be gray and the only noise I could distinguish was a swoosh. I told my daughter about it at noon time when she came home for lunch. I definitely know that was a U.F.O. - because I have never seen anything like it before or since."

\*\*\*\*\*

Lillie Brown of Modesto, California tells of her 1942 sighting in the June 1954 issue of Fate magazine.....

"I will never forget an incident that happened in September 1942. One Saturday afternoon my husband and my nine-year-old grandson took a walk to my sister's farm. My husband told me to be sure to lock up the garage that night. I was closing the door when I saw in the northeastern sky a beautiful wheel of all colors. The wheel seemed to be coming straight toward me and I noticed that one spoke was missing. As it reached our back lot it turned, moved away and hovered for a minute over our neighbor's house. Then it went north towards Modesto."

\*\*\*\*\*

Another early California sighting comes from Wilberta M. Finley of Santa Barbara in California.....

"One night in October, 1943, I was sitting on my balcony, looking across the lemon-covered hills of Hope Ranch to the Goleta Valley which stretches up the coast from Santa Barbara. It was war time and homes along the coast were ordered to use blackout shades to darken the surroundings. We were classified as a critical area, for a large Marine training base was located at Goleta, not far from our civilian airport. The only visible lights were the twinkling stars in the night sky. It was a little after nine o'clock and the moon was just beginning to throw a pale light into the darkness overhead. I became aware of a huge dark aerial object approaching our house. It moved soundlessly out of the darkness, seeming just barely to skim over the hill which lay between our home and the clear sweep to the Goleta airport and the Marine base. From the front of the object a beam of light shot down at an angle toward the earth. At intervals it swung from side to side as if scanning the hills and homes below. I sat on my balcony with terror, too frozen to move. (too frozen with terror to move! eds error again) I realized that the object was flying very low, for it filled my view and seemed just barely to miss hitting our two-story house as it passed overhead. There was no hum of a motor, no windows I was able to see. I was conscious only of the hugeness of the 'thing', its beam of light scanning the earth like an evil eye, and the intense fright which it created in me. I was unable to discern its shape, for it was upon me before I realized it. I knew, however, that I had seen nothing like it during my many months of air-spotting for the Civilian Air Command."



# WHY THE STUDY OF UFO'S?

"I believe the flying  
saucers come from  
worlds outside our  
solar system."

Our known state of the world today is this: that our  
neighbor planets are effectively inhabited by intel-  
ligent beings. Wide-spread through this belief may  
be, the fact has not let itself be known in a -  
scientific manner.

For my part, I would rather admit the contrary for  
the majority of the planets. However, in our own

galaxy, there exists many solar systems similar to ours. Most of these sun-  
systems have planets. Plus, there exists again, millions of galaxies similar to  
ours.

So, it is more than probable that there exists outside of the earth, intelligent  
beings. Here we design ourselves as intelligent beings: this is a question of  
definition. As concerns the fact of UFO observations, it is evident that, if  
there exists 70,000 visual testimonials, we cannot pass up these facts. To con-  
sider that there are space vessels coming from other worlds is a hypothesis that  
is not in contradiction with the observations: and these observations serve to  
affirm the hypothesis.

Since man has possessed a written history, he wrote of luminous discs called -  
'circles' by the ancient Egyptians. The Romans spoke of luminous metal that ap-  
peared in the heavens from time to time. Today, we don't know what we should  
name them.

The expression 'Flying Saucers' does not please me. It brings to mind the tra-  
gedies of the kitchen. The expression 'Radiant Vessels' does not please me enti-  
rely either, for they are not radiant at all times, and it is possible that the  
radiant glow is a secondary phenomena.

In the places where these testimonials have been registered, and where we have  
kept records of these testimonials, we have been able to reduce, as the saying  
goes, half of those testimonials to known causes: balloons, planes, lightning,  
etc. etc. Yet, there still remains 11% of the cases that cannot be explained in  
this manner. We should not consider as lies, contacts by radar, unimpeachable  
testimony from veteran aviation officers and authentic photographs, some of which  
have had their authenticity corroborated via lie detector tests. All these tes-  
timonies are so in accord that we can conclude they derive from a common cause.

In these well authenticated cases, all of the particulars are in agreement and  
are well known to all of you who have done research on this subject.

It is my contention that scientists should consider these things as being possi-  
ble, as long as the facts remain indisputable and there can be found no proof  
that they are impossible.

"Why The Study Of UFO's?"- by - Dr. Hermann Oberth

Scientists should consider each hypothesis, up until observations are made that contradict the existing hypothesis. For instance, it has been suggested that these phenomena may be semi-material, or para-psychological. This, in one word, suggests the possibility of ghosts, or phantoms. Today there exists many universities and institutions that study para-psychological phenomena. Never-the-less, this explanation does not satisfy me, for up until today, it has not even been proven in a sure manner that ghosts exist. In order for this hypothesis to be plausible, we must be sure that ghosts exist, for an explanation that loses itself into the unknown is not an explanation.

This does not mean that we should not accept this hypothesis as a possibility, or that it should not be followed up. I am simply saying that I, personally, prefer the explanation that the UFO's are flying machines. To this day, we have not found any other plausible explanation. Also, this does not mean that any one of these explanations 'only or alone' is convenient, and so, the UFO's could again be something altogether different.

If we accept the hypothesis that the UFO's are 'flying machines' we should equally admit the following points: A) These machines are not constructed by men of this earth, for they were seen centuries before man even learned to build the airplane, and even today are incapable of building machines that perform like the UFO's.

B) We have to admit that these flying machines maneuver with the help of an artificial magnetic field. This explains their sudden change of direction at great speed. If we could construct a similar apparatus, capable of sudden change of direction at great speeds, men would be projected against the inner walls of the ship so violently that they would be killed. However, when employing an artificial magnetic field, the occupant would fall with the ship, and there would not exist any tension between him and the apparatus. This would also explain why, when the UFO's have been seen departing from the Earth, they have been seen to enter into a huge cigar-shaped mother vessel, for in this way it would be necessary to employ only one magnetic field for a whole fleet of ufo's on their journey through space.

C) The UFO's create very strong electrical forces producing strong magnetic fields that influence the ionized air at great heights. This mode of operation also explains the luminosity of the ufos. Also this will explain the silence of the ufo's. Our airplanes, moving through the immobile air, produce violent turbulence - thereby creating noise. For the ufo there is no turbulence, for in the proximity of the apparatus, the air has the same speed as the apparatus itself. Its speed - that of the air - diminishes progressively in measure as the air is, more and more, furthered from the ufo. There exists approximately the same difference between a torrent and a brook. They can both have the same speed at the middle, but for the brook, the speed of the water diminishes progressively toward its borders. The water does not form turbulence and it rolls without noise. In contrast - the torrent groans.

Thus, with this hypothesis, we explain the glow that has often, but not always, been surrounding the vessel as tremendous electric and magnetic forces.

I have listened to some people who explained that the gravitational fields emanate from the interior of the UFO, and that they flow always towards the exterior. Thus I understood for the first time how the luminosity is produced, why the UFO's are silent, and why they are gathered up by a mother ship when departing, and so, many things have been clarified for me. This hypothesis the, may prove to be - correct.



## ANTIGRAVITY CRAFT

Nature's Anti-gravity Devices



- It is a well established principle that man does not and cannot create something out of nothing: he can only transform things which already exist. In fact, his so-called 'inventions' are really just discoveries, for, these devices, contraptions or whatever you want to call them were previously in Nature as such or at least in principle.

- For instance, thousands of years ago some scientifically minded human realized what everybody simply knew: it's the wind, not goblins, that blows twigs -leaves and other such items around and up. Furthermore, he took special notice of the well-known fact that, everything else being equal, the broader the leaf the greater the push. Hence, applying this principle, he invented the sail-boat. This fabrication was easy for the simple reason that the 'distance' between the input and the output is very short and the connection between the two is crystal clear.

- Not so with respect to the electrical motor: Homo sapiens had been on earth for at least 700,000 years when he finally discovered electricity, and it took him 2,400 more years to harness it. Yet, this force had manifested its presence frequently in the clouds during thunderstorms, probably also in his coiffure and at his fingertips once in a while. 'Watt' took him so long to find it and put it to work? Here, the cause-effect link is long, tortuous and nebulous.

- Now, the so-called 'force' of gravity is far more universal both in time and in place than any other force whatsoever, and yet, no one really knows exactly what it is and how it works. Once more I suggest that here also as with other man-made devices, the researcher who looks into Nature for a 'device' which somehow masters gravity DIRECTLY by creating something like antigravi-

tons, will be the discoverer of the greatest scientific breakthrough of the century. Sooner or later he will come upon at least two such 'contrivances', and, while studying them carefully, he will find that Nature has generously produced several 'models'. Strangely enough, this ingenious man will not be one who is involved in the field of mechanics. He will be a chemist, more specifically, a biochemist. Indeed, it has been my contention for quite some time that the chloroplasts, especially those of the genus Heliotropium, sometimes gyrate in a way which appears to cancel itself and/or 'create' its exact opposite: anti-gravity.

- In the course of his investigation this biochemist will probably find that it's adenosine triphosphate which gives the chloroplasts their weird power to defy gravity and rise. As he peruses the literature on this topic, he will take note of the fact that recently it was demonstrated that this compound is the sine qua non for the rise of the sap in plants. Up to the time this great finding was made scientists could not account satisfactorily for the RISE of sap up tall trees. However, exactly HOW ATP does it, is not yet known! I suggest, as I shall explain later, that the crystals in it transform the thermal energy they receive, or produce, into coherent, uniform oscillations which cancel the gravitational waves under certain particles in the sap. At any rate, ATP is now known to - (over)

play a fundamental role in most biological processes which either produce or require energy. For example, when an animal oxidizes glucose, ATP is produced and later, when this compound is hydrolyzed, energy is one of the products whereby the muscles are able to contract. There is also NEGATIVE geotropism by which plants, including even some of the achlorophyllous ones, defy gravity, causing at least some of their stems to grow vertically upwards. Here too, perhaps, we have a "mechanism" which generates antigravitons.

#### "The Brain Produces Antigravitons"

- Furthermore, some sentient organisms too, I believe, are able to change the polarity of certain gravitational fields. Study carefully and open-mindedly, if you can, the neoscientific experiments reported for instance by Dr. Andrew Puharich, by the late Dr. Nandor Fodor and by many other conservative researchers in the field of paranormal phenomena. You will probably find that you'll have to do like Galileo and break the shackles of traditionalism:.....

- Admit that poltergeistism, apportism, teleportation, telekinesis and a few other ultra-normal phenomena in that category are genuine, physical events. In a paper which I entitled Psychrosynthesis, I gave evidence, I believe, that this tele-nergism is another exemplification of Einsteins' theories: a gravitational field comprises waves which basically are a kind of electromagnetic wave; that mass can be transformed into energy and vice versa.

- Now, gravity is inherent to and concomitant with mass. Hence, it seems logical to conclude that, since certain agents are able to convert matter into pure energy, these same agents should be able to cause this 'packet' of energy to travel with the speed of light, not only through empty space, as the 'regular' electromagnetic waves do, but even through the densest substances just as the gravitational fields are known to do. Then, that agent should be able to stop this 'packet' of energy and metamorphose it into its original state: matter. Numerous cases, considered with their circumstances, in my judgement, indicate that teleporters, apporters and others with specific ESP talents in that category are able to do that/and/or cause objects to move visibly from place to place.

#### "Crystals Excited In Vacuo Yield Antigravitons"

- Are there laboratory experiments which show that gravity can be 'lassoed, tamed and harnessed?' - Indeed, there are! - For example, according to Leonard Cramp, a British engineer, there is a Viennese physicist: Felix Ehrenhaft who weirdly lifted particles of graphite. He put these speks in a glass flask in which he then created a VACUUM. As soon as he focused light on the glass he saw some of the particles rise into the empty space and describe ellipses, circles and spirals. They came down as soon as the light was cut off completely or diminished to a given extent. Photographs prove the objectivity of the event, plus the fact that each particle rotated on its main axis while revolving in its orbit. Probably, the kind of glass used and many other factors are essential to the success.

- In a previous paper, which I'll name later, I pointed out that in the various manifestations of the elusive antigravitation there are a few conditions common to all: crystals (or crystalline state), extrinsic-rhythmic energization of these and vacuity.

- Here, I must stress two facts: (1) The UFO's are physically real space ships or probes from other worlds; (2) there are Superhumans on the Moon and they definitely have interplanetary spacecraft. I most certainly do not expect you to take my word for it. On the other hand, I do expect that, before you deny these statements you will study carefully at least a score of reliable books on this topic, plus a few hundred articles. If you don't do at least that much, you will not be one iota better than the pundits of the Middle Ages who refused to investigate thoroughly. In order to believe in the existence of intelligences on the Moon you need not blister your meanings. Just clear your mind of prejudice and ponder over the very words of the selenographers themselves as they describe the many signs of intelligent activities on the lunar surface. - Begin with Schroter and run through the entire gamut including Greenacre and dozens of other astronomers, who, since the fall of 1963, have observed on or near the lunar 'crust' scores of gigantic space ships hovering or moving in geometric formations.

- Soon The Moon, a paper which I compiled this summer is a mere summary of the pertinent cases. Lest you misunderstand, let me state clearly that I don't pretend that I discovered something. I only UN-covered what the astronomers, willy-nilly, had already discovered. The wonder is not that I did it...but that it wasn't done a long time ago...long before I was born.

#### "Selenites Harnessed Antigravity Years Ago"

- How did they do it? To begin with, is that what they are using for "fuel"? - I believe so, as I tried to show in an earlier paper: "The UFO And Its Fuel! Their world being very different from ours and in many fundamental ways, Nature's antigravitational 'mechanisms' may be as obvious there as the wind here, that led to the invention of our sailboat. First, the Moon is immersed in an infinite vacuum. And, by the way, in case you are adamantly sure that life on the lunar surface is impossible read "Soon The Moon" and you will see that many radiophysicists have discovered a luxuriant flora there, although they don't dare say so explicitly. As for the Intelligences, the selenographers found them 200 years ago. Incidentally, what the experts find in the Ranger-7-pics confirms my theory and its subdivisions: an extremely intelligent lunar race lives on the floor of a deep, thick, wooly, etc.-forest, which, among other things, protects them as our atmosphere protects us.

- However, our atmosphere does more than protect us: it kindles our 'fuel'(food), 'sparks' our engines, etc., etc. I speculate that the so-called lunar 'crust', being in the very words of various teams of photometrists, radiophysicists, and other such specialists, "a fibrous material, finely divided, randomly ramificating, etc. etc.," affects solar radiations and/or perhaps cosmic particles in such a way as to cause some of them to 'mysteriously' levitate certain loose objects from the floor of the forest. The surface gravitational field being only  $g/6$  and there being no atmosphere, no motion of air, an antigravitational field could easily be detected and then harnessed.

- In the field of speculation, both the possibilities and even the probabilities are numerous. And so, it occurs to me that very likely the Selenites came to the knowledge and then the understanding of the baffling 'force' of gravity through, not one, but several avenues. Here on planet-3 it took Homo-sapiens a million of years to finally harness electricity. That is perhaps due, not so much to his inherent stupidity, but to the fact that on our world there are so many factors that hide the link between this mysterious energy and its effects.

- On the Moon, however, since there is neither air nor vapor, electrical discharges must have some effects which are more outstanding and visible: the connection between cause and effect may be clearer. Piezoelectricity, for instance, discharging between two poles immersed in a vacuum would find no air nor moisture to resist and distort. Hence, in this gap it should produce a rather effective electromagnetic field. From that one can easily visualize that once in a while under very specific circumstances created by the position of the sun, the presence of certain crystals, etc.-one of those fields would be of the proper intensity, frequency and direction to cancel out or even reverse the gravitational field between a loose object and the Moon, thus causing it to rise. 

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\* If you think that this hypothesis is too far fetched, recall that Einstein figured, among other things, that the gravitational field is just another species of electromagnetic field. As a matter of fact, it has been demonstrated many times since that a beam of light from a star is really affected by the gravitational field of the sun as it passes 'near' it. As a result its spectral lines shift toward the lower frequencies, i.e. the red end of the spectrum, thus losing energy. But, our specific question concerns the opposite: do electromagnetic waves affect gravity? As of last year, the answer seems to be yes, for Dr. Erwin J. Saxl, who after 10 years of experimentation, finally found that de facto gravity and electricity really react on each other.

- And there is yet another channel through which the selenites probably came to the real understanding and then mastering of this 'hidden force'. The theory is based mainly on a hypothesis propounded years ago by Nikola Tesla, a prodigious inventor. He told some of his fellow-scientists that he had plans for making an aircraft which would use sound as 'fuel'. Fearing that someone might steal his ideas, here as with all his many inventions, he never wrote down this fabulous formula. It has been for quite some time my fond belief and hope that our scientists or engineers will re-discover this amazing principle. It will be those, I think, who are experts in high frequencies. That was Tesla's forte. Now, our scientists are constantly increasing the frequencies of ultrasonics. Dr. Donald J. Hughes in his book: "The Neutron Story", seems to say that if the energy imparted to an atom is successively increased, there will come a time when the atom - itself, having reached the highest frequency possible, will no longer increase its acoustical vibrations. The added energy which it will continue to receive will henceforth be absorbed directly, not by the atom as a whole, but by some of the subatomic particles, namely the electrons. They, as a result, will emit infrared rays and perhaps visible light.

- The re-discovery of sound as 'fuel' for propulsion, etc. will probably be made accidentally as our astronauts walk around in that large vacuum chamber now being built near Houston, Texas. However, as I see it, all the basic environmental factors prevailing on the lunar surface will have to be present. One, which I'm afraid, will be ignored in this simulator is the fact that the so-called lunar 'crust' is actually a thriving vegetation which covers every square inch of the real lunar crust far below. Unless all these above-mentioned teams of specialists are wrong, the trunks, stems, branches, etc. of this exotic flora are completely covered by variously branching fibers, which, as individuals are invisible just as the droplets of water in our fogs, but which affect light in a way not yet duplicated although so far hundreds of models have been tested.

- So, probably the solar energy which will strike the floor of this lunar chamber will have to pass through material structured according to those findings before it causes the crystals below to reverse gravity. I am almost sure that the 'experts' will laugh at me scornfully when they hear about these, my very personal theories, and so I do not expect them to spend one red penny out of their multi-billion-dollar program in order to comply with my "specifications."


- However, I feel sure that someone, somewhere, here or abroad, will be open-minded enough to try to understand what I am saying and then will attempt some of the experiments I suggest. I visualize that perhaps this scientific breakthrough will be accomplished, not in a multi-million-dollar laboratory, but in a poor man's cellar on a dingy workbench. And now, here is a summary of what, to my mind, he should do in order to re-detect the principle and the 'fuel' by which the above-mentioned trillion-dollar space craft, already on the Moon, are propelled.

- There are good reasons to believe that the lunar crust contains a mixture of many kinds of crystals and other 'building blocks', which are very much like what we find here on our world. However, there must be differences. For example, since the Moon is 'immersed' in an infinite vacuum, the inorganic substances on its surface must be absolutely dry. Hence, I suggest that the researcher obtain several kinds of soil, natural rock dusts, powders and the like so that probably at least one of them will suit the purpose.

- Then he should sift them in order to remove roots, leaves and other such pieces of organic matter. In the meantime or afterwards he should mix them together randomly. Finally, the mixture should be placed in a bell jar within a vacuum which should be created while solar heat and light beam on the pile.

- Maybe this simple procedure alone will be sufficient to cause some of these particles to rise weirdly. If that happens, the next step would be to find out what kind of particles rise: how are they structured? What is their chemical composition, etc.

- However, the investigator will probably not be that successful so soon. In that case he should try to simulate more closely the real environment on the lunar surface. For instance, maybe the source of light, heat and/or other radiations must be in the vacuum itself, and furthermore, maybe these waves and/or particles must be made to pass through a very finely divided, fibrous material with almost 100% opacity, etc. etc. as it is on

the Moon. There is also the factor of gravity ( $g/6$ ), which perhaps can't be ignored. Everything being equal otherwise, a gravitational field at that low level would obviously permit objects to rise more easily. Also, the van der Waals forces would probably be more effective, and this could bring about important structural differences. That in turn could very well give certain crystals the capacity to produce antigravitons out of the electromagnetic energy and/or cosmic particles.

- If the above mentioned experiments with light, heat and perhaps radioactive matter fail, I suggest that the would-be discoverer try other sections of the long electromagnetic spectrum, for instance electrical fields. Recall that Dr. Saxl demonstrated experimentally that electricity reacts on gravity.

- Now, on 'our' natural satellite there being neither air nor moisture, there is very little or no interference, and so electrical fields must be far more effective than they would be otherwise. From that consideration one can easily see (visualize) how piezoelectricity, which is easily produced by various agents, probably yields weird effects when it discharges unimpeded at a gap between two poles 'immersed' in a complete vacuum. Maybe then it generates antigravitons.

- Then there is also the probability that there are a few natural photocells on the Moon and that they are actually the antigravitational devices.

- Finally, the would-be inventor should keep in mind the fact that a given gravitational field is very uniform in many aspects. So, if one wants to cancel it or reverse it, he will probably have to use an 'interferometer' and/or 'reverser' which is also uniform. The maser and its cousin, the laser, have, among other things, the ability to harmonize at least certain frequencies. Now, perhaps.... Nature has planted several such and/or similar 'devices' on the lunar surface.

- Why couldn't there be one for each species of the electromagnetic waves? Why couldn't there be an 'infrarayser', an 'X-rayser', etc.? These and other such 'contraptions' could very well have been produced by various members of the - thriving lunar flora.

## Air Force Denies UFO Reports

WASHINGTON — Several sightings of Unidentified Flying Objects (UFO) have been reported from Washington and vicinity during the past month. The Air Force and the Defense Department continue to deny that citizens saw what they thought they saw; in other words, to deny that the

UFOs are real.

One reported sighting that got on TV here and into the newspapers concerned a dozen alleged white oval-shaped objects sighted by several from the Munitions Building which is close to the Lincoln Memorial. Five Army communications systems specialists, whose names have been published, state the objects were at over 12,000 feet and were outdistancing two jet planes that were chasing them. The UFO's were visible for several minutes as they moved "erratically", it is stated.

### Navy Report

Another report came from the Patuxent Naval Air Station near Washington. It was "the Navy" and not individuals that reported two strange objects on the station's radar screen, according to published reports. The objects were approaching the station from about 30 miles away at a speed of 4800 miles an hour. So far as the public knows we don't possess two planes with that speed. The two objects on the Patuxent scope made a sharp turn and disappeared from the radar.

As regards the sighting from the Munitions Building, observed by the five named and by others, a spokesman for the Defense Department retorted that "there was no such incident". This denial has not been convincing to the sighters who repeat they saw what they said they saw.

### Radar Was Wrong

The report by the two radar operators at Patuxent is disposed of by the Air Force with the statement that the radar was wrong, that either it was just out of kilter or it was "reacting" to some other electronic device at the station.

To experts in the field of Unidentified Flying Objects — this designation was given them by the Air Force itself —

— all this is a familiar pattern. For years the Air Force has been contending that the UFO's are not real, that most of the reports represent honest misidentification of familiar objects. A number of scientists, many experts in the realm of the atmosphere, several veteran plane pilots, some members of Congress and others hold that some of the UFO's are real and unknown.

The maintained attitude of the Air Force in the controversy has resulted in charges of censorship and unjustified secrecy and an intentional and successful misleading of the public. To several observers here who have studied the UFO situation over the years many of the Air Force explanations of reported sightings don't explain.

### LURED THOUSANDS

As a result of the boy's whimsical scheme, professors from four colleges, Air Force personnel and tourists by the thousands flocked to the wooded area off E.

Focer st. in Glassboro to inspect the "spaceship" landing site.

Coppolino told how Hallowitz and two friends carried out the scheme during an overnight camping trip.

The boys dug a crater, then punched out three "tripod" holes and above these broke off the branches of a tree. Then they set a fire in the center of the crater and sprinkled some sulfa potassium and radium dioxide about the area to make it appear radioactive.

### STARTED RUMOR

After leaving the area, Hallowitz found two small boys fishing and told them he had seen

a "red glowing object" land about a half mile away. The boys, Ward Campbell, Jr., 11, and his brother, Don, 8, told their father who notified police.

Police uncovered the hoax after Hallowitz, using the name Hallow, tried to sell the story to a local weekly newspaper.

After Coppolino finished his testimony, Hallowitz entered a plea of guilty to charges of being a disorderly person and issuing a false alarm.

### CITES MAN-HOURS

Judge Lawrence Myers then asked Coppolino if he had any recommendations to offer and Coppolino said:

"He is a studious boy, but there have been many man-hours spent on this case."

The Judge fined Hallowitz \$50, then suspended the fine, but told the youth he had to pay \$10 court costs.

Until two weeks ago, Hallowitz had been a student at Glassboro State College. Then he had a falling out with his parents and moved out of the home on Princeton st. Since then he has been working at a bowling alley.

## Oyster Bay Group Plans Local Study Of Flying Saucers

### Recently Formed Organization Is Headed By John Prytz, Senior At High School Here

Under the leadership of John Prytz, a senior at Oyster Bay High School, a new group has been formed to study and analyze reports of Unidentified Flying Objects (UFO's), more commonly known as "Flying Saucers" here.

The organization, which has a strong mutual interest in all types of aerial phenomena of which UFO's form a major part, meets every other Saturday night at the home of the group's director, Mr. Prytz, at 21 McCouns Lane. At these meetings lively discussion on the UFO and allied subjects take place. The group is called The Oyster Bay UFO Investigative Committee (OBUIC), and membership is open at no cost to anyone who has an open mind on the subject.

Reports of UFO sightings come into OBUIC from all over the United States as well as from several foreign countries. The committee is concerned not only with analyzing these reports, but also with writing articles on these sightings and conducts surveys in the field, of which both types have appeared in leading UFO magazines.

OBUIC has so far corresponded with such leading UFO researchers as George Adamski of California, Armand A. Laprade from Massachusetts, James Rigberg of New York City, and Gladys Fusaro in Huntington. OBUIC is also working in close association with the Rissler Observatory in Philadelphia, The National Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomena (NICAP) in Washington D. C., Flying Saucer News Club of America in New York City, Interplanetary News Service and Saucer News both out of New Jersey.

### Plans Local Study Of Flying Saucers

In addition to his regular studies and being an active member of the high school band, Mr. Prytz among other UFO activities, has found time to deliver interesting talks to three of his individual classes on the subject of UFO's at Oyster Bay High School and he is scheduled to deliver a lecture to the entire senior high school body on UFO's next March. He is also planning to give one in New York City sometime in the near future.

The majority of the members of OBUIC have seen at one time or another strange flying objects in our atmosphere. Mr. Prytz himself has seen and recorded in OBUIC's files, six UFO sightings in and around Oyster Bay and has had some of these published. He has also personally obtained an additional twenty sightings from members of the community.

When asked about any conclusions the group might have reached to date, Mr. Prytz answered, "Something of an unknown nature is definitely going on in the skies above us and has been doing so for many hundreds of years now. We here are attempting to find out what that something might be. UFO's are no joking matter. Flying Saucers are real!"

Upon graduation from high school, Mr. Prytz plans to enter the Air Force to continue his investigations of these mysterious unknown objects.

# UFO's Seen As Vehicles By Local Saucer Sighter

The United States Air Force is persisting in its "Big Brother" attitude toward the American people as regards unidentified flying objects, according to a Cinnaminson man.

Michael J. Campione, 2202 New Albany road, director of a new local branch of Amalgamated Flying Saucer Clubs of America, Inc., claims a personal sighting of a UFO, plus personal knowledge of a mass sighting in Philadelphia, which he offers as evidence that UFO's are not only real, they are most likely manned vehicles from outer space. Still, according to Campione, the Air Force will not acknowledge that UFO's exist.

"I used to follow the news of UFO's in the papers before it became too commonplace and they stopped carrying it. This was back around 1950 or '51.

"I never saw one myself until last winter---right here in Cinnaminson. It wasn't a saucer, but a UFO of another shape.

### LIKE A JET

Campione described the craft as a flying object resembling an Air Force jet trainer, but bristling with antenna-like fuzz along the edges of its silhouette. The object had no semblance of a tail section such as is common to conventional aircraft.

According to Campione, the sighting took place at 5:20 a.m., December 13, 1963, and started with his observation of a "bright pinpoint of light." He said that as the object grew larger rapidly, as though traveling at enormous speed, the whole of it was glowing with a light green phosphorescent color. "two narrow, wing-like projections extended out from either side of the 'fuselage' in the same relative position as wings on a conventional aircraft. On each 'wing tip' was what resembled a conventional wingtip fuel tank, only it was shorter and stubbler."

### LASTED SECONDS

Campione said that the sighting lasted only about three or four seconds, beginning when the craft was over Route 73, as viewed from his New Albany road home, and ending with the object disap-

pearing in the sky over Moores-town. The distance covered was approximately eight miles, he said, at an altitude of perhaps 3000 feet.

The Cinnaminson man also cited the experience of his friend, Zigmund Hill, Philadelphia, who, with his wife, daughter, and niece, was relaxing at his home when sighting occurred, May 23, 1962. In addition to his son, who called Hill's attention to the object, five neighbors also bore witness.

### CRAFT 'HOVERS'

According to Hill's account, the craft was hovering 2 blocks away. It appeared to resemble an inverted saucer, with six portholes and a dome-like cabin with a large window from which glowed a green light.

Two jet planes appeared on the scene, to be joined by two propeller-driven planes. As they converged, the UFO made a figure 6 maneuver and disappeared. When the planes tired of searching and retired, the UFO returned.

The original sighting had lasted 5 minutes, and, after it returned, it continued a hide-and-seek game with the planes for another 40 minutes.

Hill said the craft was so close on occasion that it looked like "a grapefruit held at arm's length."

### CHIDED BY AIR FORCE

Later, according to Campione, an Air Force representative in uniform visited Hill and chided him about the sighting. The Air Force man made reference to "weather balloons, hallucinations and the like" in explaining away the UFO.

Campione exhibited an Air Force form purported to be used in such cases, which would point out that the Air Force is seeking information on objects that they claim do not exist.

There are three possibilities in regard to the UFO puzzle, according to Campione: 1) they are United States devices or vehicles; 2) they are Russian devices or vehicles; 3) they are (as hardcore UFO believers insist) interplanetary vehicles or vehicles from under the surface of the earth. Campione favors number 3

because sightings predate man's ability to fly.

As far as the Amalgamated Flying Saucer Clubs of America is concerned, it is an organization said to have 3000 members from all over the world. It was organized in 1959 in Los Angeles by a man named Gabriel Green

### WILDER WORDS

Campione's statements represent a point of view not generally embraced by most citizens, but Green's pronouncements, as printed in his "UFO International," cannot be described in so charitable a manner. Following are excerpts from the text of a radio message, supposedly received by a UFO believer, from "space people";

(Special radio message received by Bob Renaud, 3 a.m., February 2, 1964.) "Greetings, Brother: We, your space friends from the planet Korendor, are speaking to you now from your moon, specifically Mare Serenitatis (Sea of Tranquility), where, as you know, the Ranger 6 space probe was scheduled to take pictures before crash landing on the lunar surface this A.M.

"You will recall that in our brief communication to you yesterday morning, we told you that the probe was approaching a temporary base that we had just recently set up in this area. Also, that we would be forced to prevent the taking of any pictures of this area, for security reasons.

"Your news reports have now confirmed that this action was taken. What they do NOT say, because they do not KNOW, is that the probe never hit the surface. It was taken aboard one of our spaceships a mile from the lunar surface, and is now under intensive study in our labs here on the moon.

"This may be the required action for the next probe also, unless we can finish our work in Mare Serenitatis and dismantle the base before Ranger 7 is sent on its way."

Maybe they were just early for the Inauguration. At any rate, two dozen civilian communication specialists for the Army (who sound like sober, sane people) reported seeing 15 white, oval-shaped objects zig-zagging some 12,000 feet above Capitol Hill in Washington earlier this month. This game of "what is it?" has been going BOTHWELL on ever since Kenneth Arnold's historic Mount Ranier sighting back in 1947.

Here in St. Petersburg, Mrs. Joan Whritenour, 6464 34th Ave. N., heads a UFO Club of some 30 members, which meets at her home every other Tuesday at 8 p.m.

**"We're a non-profit, non-political, non-religious group, open to the public, to all who have open minds — we hold what amounts to an open discussion period. Nine out of ten members have seen things — they don't know what."**

"I myself have seen what some people tell me are dream fireballs — directly over my house, the most beautiful shade of kelly green. And my neighbors and friends have seen the same thing."

There have been very good sightings on the East Coast — and last November, from the 5th through the 30th, club members tracked an object as big and bright as Jupiter two and three times a night.

It was reported to the Air Force, which sent back a politely skeptical letter but asked for pictures, if any. (About 8 per cent of the 8,908 U.S. sightings since 1947 defy human logic.)

Mrs. Whritenour agrees the field has been exploited by fast buck operators, who will sell you a record of a conversation with a Martian, or a book about a young lady's love affair with some traveling salesman from Saturn.

But she is sure that behind all the hokum there is some genuine answer:

**"I've always been interested in anything of this nature; to me UFOs are mysteries that should be solved. Just the fact they're here proves they're intelligent."**

So why haven't they dropped a note in a bottle or something after all these years?

"I think generally," says the UFO Club head, "they have tried very hard to make themselves known — but everyone is afraid of the unknown. I think they're as afraid of us as we are of them."

The current True Magazine, she notes, carries an article on the Air Force attitude toward UFOs by Major Donald Keyhoe, long active in the field. In it he claims, Mrs. Whritenour says, that four UFOs trailed the first Gemini capsule around the world.

The Pentagon insists it takes UFOs seriously. UFO enthusiasts around the country certainly do.

Of All Things is anxious to believe in UFOs, willing to believe in UFOs, only — why can't I ever see one?

The light "went out", the jet disappeared, then the light "came back on", hanging silently and alone.

On January 29, a housewife, near Wheaton, reported a mid-afternoon performance by five high-flying discs which "glowed with pearl-like luminescence." Well Virginians, Little Green Men May Be Here But Don't Shoot 'Em! Arkansas Gazette - 2/1/65 Richmond, Va.....At least one Virginia sheriff thinks it's okay to watch for flying saucers in the Old Dominion skies, just don't shoot the little green men reported accompanying them.

"This thing has gotten completely out of hand", says Sheriff John E. Kent of Augusta County. "It is now dangerous to county residents." Almost daily, Virginians are reporting Unidentified Flying Objects (UFO) in many parts of the state. Some have said they saw little Martian types wandering about on the ground.

"Anyone can go out at night", says Sheriff Kent, "and see reflections in the sky. But anyone carrying firearms in the County without good reason will be dealt with according to law." Besides, even if creatures from outer space have landed, "Who has the right to mow them down?", he asks.

Even the United States Air Force has gotten into the act. With typical military curtness, the Air Force has discounted any evidence confirming existence of either flying saucers or little green men. But, for the record, a spokesman adds: "Our cases are never closed until the reported objects are sufficiently identified."

Last week, a pastor added his name to a growing list of persons reporting similar sightings. Rev. H. Preston Robinson, pastor of the Chilhowie, Va., Church of God, said he saw a flying saucer over downtown Marion. "It stopped 600 feet above the ground and had a round-shaped bottom from which several lights showed", he said.

.....Two men from Richmond, Va., traveling in separate cars reported sighting a UFO near Williamsburg January 23. An Air Force spokesman later said he presumed it was a weather balloon.

Three other sightings of the mysterious flying objects were reported across the state at Waynesboro and Staunton January 15. These reports came from a housewife, a farmer and a high school student.

After one reported saucer landing, Professor Ernest Gehman of Eastern Mennonite College in Harrisburg, checked the site with a geiger counter December 20. There was a high radiation level, he reported afterward.

At Staunton last Tuesday night, three boys said they saw and chased a small, green man near a rural road. He was described as three and a half feet tall. The little green man probably was none other than Donald Cash, whose in-the-flesh statistics are somewhat more sizeable - five-foot-eight, 190 pounds.

Cash, 36, decided to lend substance to the UFO craze by donning blue (not green) overalls and a leather cap and pushing his hair straight up. - Now he's not so sure it was the right move. Some youngsters spotted him in a field, he said, and tried to run him down. He outran them.

"But it shook me up", he said. "I didn't know what they would do if they got their hands on me."

One deadly serious man, gunsmith Horace Burns of Grottoes, didn't see the little green men but did report the sound one flying saucer made when he saw it land in Augusta County. "It made a soft, whooshing sound", he said.

#### Sonic Booms Startle Area

The Philadelphia Inquirer - 1/20/65.....Delaware Valley residents, from South Jersey to Chester county, were startled Tuesday shortly after 1:30 p.m. by two reverberating sonic booms that sent many scurrying from their homes and others on hasty damage surveys of their dwellings.

The concussions, believed to have been caused by jet aircraft breaking the sound barrier, were particularly heavy in Bucks and Delaware counties and were heard as far away as 20 miles west of the city, in Chester county.

Cmdr. Robert Hollenbach, of the Willow Grove Naval Air Station, said some of its jet aircraft were in the air but that none was in supersonic flight over the area. He said the Navy pilots reported the presence of "numerous high-level aircraft that did not originate at the Willow Grove Station during the period of the disturbance." LETTER...Dept. of the Air Force, Washington. 2/9/65 - Dear Mr. Homan: Attached as requested is the Air Force evaluation of the Patuxent NAS, Maryland, UFO incident: Patuxent NAS, Maryland 29 December 1964..."Based on results of an investigation by the Patuxent NAS and analysis of information supplied to the Air Force by the Navy, it has been determined that false radar targets were mistakenly reported as unidentified flying objects on 29 Dec. 64. Study of the shape and illumination of the return indicates that they were created by some other electronic device within the station or were caused by an intermittent abnormality within the circuitry of the radar set itself. This conclusion has been further verified by a check with independent radar complex at Patuxent NAS and with adjacent radar centers on the East coast which revealed no corresponding radar return on that date." ECHO X - The St. Petersburg UFO - - - by - Joan Whritenour - Director of  
 The St. Petersburg UFO Club in

In the first week of November, 1964, there appeared on the scene here in Florida a mysterious object now known as Echo-X. This object was first sighted while waiting for the passage of Echo One. The satellite. Our skywatch team here, having the schedules of the appointed time, saw instead...an object come into view travelling in the opposite direction. (opposite direction of Echo One!)

This 'object' appeared about the same in brightness as the planet Jupiter. Its speed and general motion, as nearly as could be judged, was the same as that of the Echo satellites. - However, it cannot and should not be confused with either of the Echo satellites...due to its greater brightness.

It also has peculiar characteristics! Such as: definite turns at times - sometimes twice during one pass. (these are not just curves, but an abrupt change of general direction.) The path, at times, has tended to be more to the west than to the east of a north to south line. This object has been noted to stop and pause for 3 or 4 seconds...just before becoming invisible. On two occasions, after dimming out; a bright flash was noticed in the exact spot where the object vanished! (bright flash like a flash-bulb)

We found that, during the times specified for the passing of the Echo's, we could as a rule find this mystery object passing. In most cases, from horizon to horizon. If you did not know the schedule of the Echo's - One and Two, you would think that this X object was one of the two.

BUT.....


It definitely was not either Echo according to the schedules given...or the word of the head of the local Moonwatch Team. The schedules used in locating both the satellites were obtained from the Science Department of the Junior College. (their planetarium) It is also interesting to note that: on one occasion when Echo - X appeared...Moonwatch had previously stated that neither Echo's would be visible that evening!

The first time that Moonwatch was contacted with a request for identification of the object, he stated that it was neither satellite, that it must be a plane. He volunteered the information that Saturn 5 is sometimes visible to the naked eye, but not during this period of time. So he did not definitely discount that slim possibility. Beyond this, he was not at all interested in any further investigation. But that was not the end of it!

On the following night (the 17th), an observer phoned him, requesting that he go out and look in a specific location of the sky, and see the object for himself. He was finally persuaded to do so. Upon returning to the phone, he expressed the opinion that there were 400 objects in orbit up there, but this was not one of them! He had no idea what it was and asked to be notified if it reappeared.

On the 18th he followed the object by telescope and stated that it was at least 700 miles in height...and looked like a small round ball of light. He further said that he believed it was Echo II., and had made an error in his schedule! When informed that it had been reappearing, simultaneously with I and II, he said: "It is not unusual for both to appear at the same time. (Echo I and Echo II???) .....On the 19th, he submitted a UFO report to Cambridge, Massachusetts.)

After checking and re-checking, we too, have come to the same conclusion!! This object is definitely not a plane! There is no noise whatsoever. It's no balloon or bird. The Moon has remained in the same spot while this unknown intruder has moved across the sky. Venus is not yet up at this time and Jupiter is clearly where it belongs...at all times. There are no running lights. Just one big bright light!  
 (more...over...)



Since this investigation, and the involvement of Moonwatch, it has become impossible for us to obtain any schedules for the Echo's. He has not released them to the public and a direct call to him produced no results. It would seem he has concluded that silence is the greater part of discretion.

A full report on this object: time, passage, antics, etc. was sent to Mr. Hayden Hewes of IIOUFO. He suggested that it be placed in the hands of the Air Force. It....was! - .....

We continued to observe this object until the 30th of November after which the weather was so bad and seeing conditions poor. We have not definitely spotted it since.

One of the most peculiar sightings of this object occurred on November the 7th.....

At 7:00, it was seen from due north to due south, horizon to horizon.

At 7:45, it was from north-northeast to south-southwest.

At 9:01, Echo I was very low, from northwest to northeast.

Another peculiar sighting of this object occurred on November the 9th.....

UFO - 6:45 - northeast to southeast.

" - 8:33 - northwest toward northeast. Stopped, paused, and dimmed out.

Echo II - 8:45 - From low in the Northwest.

As you can see, it seems we have found us an Echo X!! - - - U.F.O??



# AUTHORITY - VS - Common Sense

Foreword: Before you read Mr. Adamski's article we would like to insert (here) a portion of his letter, as follows..."I read your recent article written by the Rev. Guy J. Cyr. It is a very good article. If more members of the clergy were like him, more people would be better informed as to what they can expect in the coming years." - - - -



Mr. Adamski's article: - I would like to say something about the latest Moon shot. Out of 7,500 pictures that were taken - they only showed a few and I am sure they were not the best, for the ones shown on TV were out of focus, making it more than a little hard to pin-point anything of a distinct nature. Some of the authorities said that the latest shots indicated that the lunar surface may be covered with a deep layer of dust, yet the explanations given were far from logical.

If the surface of the Moon is as soft as they say, (and the Moon does not stand still in space...it is moving faster than we realize) and even if it were moving at only 60 m.p.h. it would create an air flow around itself. On some occasions, pilots have been delayed in their flight plans by space ship activity. When these pilots returned, they had to answer and explain the reason for their delay. Not only to their superiors, but to psychiatrists who were invariably called in as soon as the pilots told what had happened. What I would like to know is: how can anyone judge another's experience when they themselves have never had a similar experience and, in some cases, have never even been up in the air!?! - Yet, these professed "experts", who may never have been in an aircraft, pass judgement on a man who has experience that they have never had. They discredit a man whose information could be of great help in saving time and money in this new field of space exploration. 

Mr. Ray Kenney of Woonsocket, R.I., asks....."I have always been interested in ESP and would like to know what methods one might use, in the home, to determine whether or not one possesses this sixth sense?"

Answer.....There are many ways for you to test your own ability or others. I feel it is best to have a partner when first beginning on your venture. Take a deck of ordinary playing cards and select ten cards at random. Then you and partner sit down in a quiet room and have him visualize, in his mind, whether the card that he holds in his hand is red or black. Then, you try to visualize in your mind which color it is. Now, of course, the element of chance is quite great, but when you actually SEE the color within your own mind, you will feel certain that you are right! Imagine that your mind is a blank movie screen and that you are waiting for the show to begin. As you watch the screen, try to SEE the card that your partner is holding.

It may take many tries to get the right answer, but this is important, remember how you felt, inwardly when you received the right impression and use this as a guide. When you try again, wait for this 'right feeling' to come along - and you will know that you have chosen correctly!

Another test you might try, is to wait for the phone to ring or the doorbell. Before you answer it, try to see, with your 'mind's eye' who it really is. You may goof at first, but as you keep trying, you will have greater success and eventually will be able to tell who is there before you see them!

To keep your mind active, say if you are in a waiting room with time to kill, try to visualize 'who' is going to enter the room next. This may seem strange to you - but if you keep trying - you will soon find that you are right about 6 out of 10 times! Really 'try to see' the person, what they are wearing, etc. For example: Is it a man? A woman? A child? - Take the very first impression that comes into your mind. Don't try to rationalize what you feel.

Another method is - to carefully not watch the clock for about one hour. Then, when you are in a room where there is no clock, try to feel and think what time it is. If you feel it is 2:04, write it down, then go look at the clock. See how close you can get to the correct time. Again, patience is the by-word.

Dr. Rhine's ESP cards would also be of great help to you. Buy or make a deck of them. Any library has books on ESP and you could get the information about the cards there. They have geometric patterns. There are many other ways for you to exercise your mind but I think that just a few are best when beginning. As you go along, and wish to advance or further your knowledge, I shall suggest more.

Mrs. Helen Ciccone of Blackstone, Mass. - "I am not a firm believer in ESP, but I have heard of strange tales-sometimes involving one or more people who, upon finding themselves in great stress, and with no one knowing their whereabouts, found themselves suddenly rescued by someone who claimed to have had a mental image of their hopeless situation. My question then is, is it possible for a person in trouble to transmit a strong telepathic message without a predetermined effort to do so?"

Answer: It is very possible for one in distress to broadcast their thoughts or their predicament to those who have absolutely no personal knowledge of either them, or their location. It is truly a long, involved explanation, but I shall try to be explicit.

Scientists now know that what we call 'telepathy', or the sending of signals from one mind to another, really involves an electrical type of process. Each and everyone of us is a sort of signal generator, sometimes these signals or impulses are more or less scattered, and they dissipate into the ether surrounding us with no visible effect on either ourselves, or others. The emotions of a person, such as one in distress, tend to raise these signals to a higher frequency and an increase in voltage.

As I have said before, some of us are senders, and some are receivers. Most of the time without our conscious knowledge of any of the processes involved. Perhaps a person, quite uninvolved with another, can perceive this SOS signal, because they themselves are good receivers. Thoughts and emotions are constantly surrounding us 'every minute' and sometimes the receiver will unconsciously tune - in to an event or situation without even trying to.

Science discovered the "electroencephalograph", which measures electrical impulses given off by the human brain. These impulses can be used in many ways, primarily to diagnose illnesses of the brain. - Thus they have established, on a scientific basis, the theory that all thought creates a certain amount of 'energy', the stronger the thought, the more energy output. Just as some radios are good for only a local area, so are some receivers of thought. Others seem to pick up signals generated from afar.

As the emotions raise the blood pressure, increase heart action, and increase the adrenalin dosage to the various parts of the human body, emotion also increases the energy output of thought within the human brain. (example, try this.) Place your hand on your throat and say aloud - something in a normal tone of voice or emotion. Then - say aloud, something of a startling nature, such as yelling for H E L P! - Then feel the difference between the vibrations of a normal and an emotional or excited voice! - This same effect happens when the thoughts are normal or in an emotional state. The higher frequency of the vibrations are what transmit your thoughts to the nearest, tunable or in tune, receiver!!

Editors Note: Before proceeding with the next question and answer, we include the following bit of information....On Tuesday, January 28, 1965, Dr. Edmond M. Dewan (physicist at the Air Force Cambridge Research Laboratories at Hanscom AFB in Bedford, Mass.), became the first layman in history to communicate with another human being by brain wave transmission. It took him nearly two minutes to send a two-word message..."c-a-n d-o", using electrical impulses generated by starting and stopping his brain waves. He used electrodes attached to the base of the skull to transmit alpha rhythms generated by the brain. A stronger amplifier was built, boosting the brain wave output enough to turn a lamp on and off. And no doubt many persons have this ability in its natural form. Others, as Joan has pointed out, can train their minds to send or receive these brain thoughts!

From Ernest J. Bordes of Woonsocket, R.I. - "Have you found through your research that children of pre-school age display a greater amount of ESP? If so, could it be possible that we all, at one time, possessed this ability but found it to be obstructed by the effects of technological progress?"

Answer - I believe that all of us possess ESP ability to some degree, others perhaps more so, but on the average we can cultivate this knowledge. (over)

Children DO seem to have this esp ability and I feel it is because they still possess an open mind, not yet exposed too much to reality. They are not cynical and suspicious of events, even strange ones. They will report what they feel and think. The problem is in getting the older generation to listen to children! If a child says something of a startling nature, the adult is prone to laugh it off as a prank or small fib. They do not credit them with much intelligence because they feel that they are too young to know anything of real value. This is wrong!

Our normal education induces us to rely on text books and tested theories, to be normal is to conform, the average person does not really think for himself or herself, they mimic the words and thoughts of others. Whereas a child is a small or miniature - intelligent adult. His hopes and fears are just as important to him as yours are. He has the natural inclination to imagine, or to see with his mind's eye, and uses this urge. We also possess the inclination to imagine, but have had individuality drummed out of us by the pressures of modern society.

The child still has his faculties clear and he uses them. I believe if we try to listen, without sitting in judgement, (to the child) we could perhaps come into knowledge that we could not have possibly received through normal channels. This does not mean that we should take for gospel everything that a child imagines as real. We should take into consideration the circumstances surrounding such a statement if unusual. If the child feels or acts strangely excited over such an instance, we should try to give credence to his words or actions.

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A space psychologist declared that scientists must explore extrasensory perception -ESP- or other mental processes as a means of communication with future astronauts who voyage millions of miles from Earth. Everett F. Dagle, chief of data sciences for the AF Cambridge Research Laboratories, told the 35th annual meeting of the Aerospace Medical Association, that there have been hundreds of examples of ESP reported. Some, involving mental contact between persons far apart, clairvoyance or precognition of events to come. He conceded none have been satisfactorily explained on a scientific basis.

Dagle said that neither the U.S., nor Russia has yet put a man in true space. "While it is true that impressive orbital flights have been made by American and Soviet astronauts", he said, "it must be realized that as they went spinning round - they still had visual reference to mother earth below them and they still were tied to her gravitational apron strings."

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Worcester, Mass. 3/4/65 - Julian F. Grow, whose article "Good Evening" which appears daily in the Evening Gazette, had this comment to make: "The authorities recently plunked a second reconnaissance missile into the moon - Ranger VIII, close on the heels of Ranger VII - and still can't figure out what kind of surface, deep dust or crusty, that the moon has. Well then, why didn't they point the cameras of Ranger VIII at the place where Ranger VII landed, and see what kind of hole Ranger VII made? - They don't know everything, those guys. Think they're so smart."

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3/7/65 - Port Moresby, Papua.....A mysterious disease called "the laughing death" is killing off the women of the Fore people of the eastern highlands of New Guinea - The ravages of the disease are such that Fore tribesmen have been forced to become housekeepers and motherless families are common. An Australian woman researcher who worked among the Fore people said that out of 76 marriages in one Fore clan, 40 wives died from "the laughing death." (officially called Kuru) The victims lose control of their limbs and facial muscles in the early stages of the disease and give the appearance of laughing continually. It affects only the Fore people and kills more women than men. There is no known cure.

Looky - looky - looky...Here Comes Spooky!! - Credit...Raymond G. Copenhaver.

He has answers on 'SPOOKLIGHT' by - Steve Bouser. - Bob Gibbons last night answered some old questions and questioned some old answers concerning the well-known "spooklight", a weird apparition visible almost every night on a lonely country road near Joplin.

Gibbons, a Drury College senior, presented his theories about the light at a student symposium at the college and backed them up with some home movies and slides he and a colleague took in 1960.

He has arrived at a surprisingly simple explanation, leaving little to one's morbid imagination. He freely admits his theory still has some holes in it but, being of a scientific bent, doesn't seem to have much patience with anyone who says anything about hobgoblins or long-dead Indian spirits.

Residents of the area, Gibbons said, - "reported seeing lights in the woods as early as 1903." Since then, he said, the vantage point from which lights can be seen has shifted.

His explanation, he pointed out, pertains only to the present one, which is along a dirt road some eleven miles s. west of Joplin, near the Missouri- Oklahoma line.

"At present", he said, "The light is seen almost every night from a half-hour after sunset to a half-hour before sunrise. It varies in intensity and time of appearance, and sometimes breaks up into distinct pairs."

"Usually it seems to float just above the hills down the roadway to the west. At rare times it seems to come toward the observer. At times it moves slightly horizontally."

There is a big problem in distinguishing accurate reports of sightings from the distorted or made-up ones. Gibbons said: one man said he saw the light set fire to a haystack...another told of the thing entering his car and burning its interior...and another reported seeing an old lady walking down the roadside with the spooklight where her head should be.

Through a 30-power telescope, Gibbons reported, "as many as four distinct pair of lights were observed, with pairs of red lights appearing slightly to the

right of pairs of bright white lights. The red lights grew dimmer as the white lights became brighter." He showed some color slides in which these red and white lights could be distinguished.

Quoting from Gibbons report: "Upon putting together a composite map of the area, I discovered that U.S. 66, running east and west from Commerce to Quapaw, Okla., was in direct line with the spook-light road and the observation point. I also noticed that Spring River was between my point of observation and distant Highway 66, 12 miles away."

"Therefore, I thought the cause of the spooklights lay in the refraction of light from automobiles moving on distant U.S. 66 in direct line with the gravel road where I stood."

"The fact that the lights did not always appear substantiated the refraction theory in that if the light from auto's were bent, it would come down at different points with various intensities, depending on the temperature and humidity of the dense atmosphere above.... Spring River. Light from a source travelling on 66 would be bent or refracted out of its normal path and would appear in the form of bouncing balls of fire on the road 12 miles away."

"The phenomenon of the white lights appearing slightly to the left of the dimmer red lights corresponds with the natural movement of traffic on a road or highway in observer, with headlights on, would appear to the left of the autos moving away, with the dim tail-lights."

At a question-and-answer session after his talk, Gibbons acknowledged that there were still some unanswered questions. Some of the questions: What about the lights seen in 1903? What about all the reports of lights seen to the east? Why do the lights look blue or green to some observers? etc.

In closing, Gibbons commented..."There's a haunted house in this country (pointing to an area on his map which he was showing some hangers-on, after most of the crowd had left) and those travelling toward the right...about here," he said soberly, "but I didn't want to go into that in my talk." - The End? -

Larry thinks it's just a light sleep-walker out for a stroll.....(very end!)

TV Stops Working After Mystery Light

Jan. 1965 - A second person has reported seeing a "mysterious light" minutes after his television set stopped working. Matthew Rybczyk said he was watching TV when all of a sudden it stopped dead.

He went outside, thinking the snow or wind had toppled his antenna. That's when he saw the mystery light. He said he also heard a humming sound. He reported the light as moving to the east at a slow rate.

A Concord man reported seeing a similar sight while driving his car on Route 4A between Wilmot and Enfield. He said his car's radio went off, his lights, and the motor stopped. He added that he heard a humming sound.

In both cases, electrical power was restored when the "mysterious light" left.

Williamsburg, Va. 1/24/65 - The James City County Sheriff's Department was investigating the reported sighting of an unidentified flying object near here Saturday. Sheriff A.M. Brenegan said he received a call from the Williamsburg City police before 9 a.m., saying a citizen reported seeing the object land in a field near Toano, about 12 miles from here.

Brenegan said he sent a deputy to investigate and that Ft. Lee was notified. The Army post dispatched two helicopters to the scene, Brenegan said. Further details were not immediately available.

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Warrnambool - 1/29/65 - Following the sighting of a satellite on Wednesday, a 'black speck' was sighted just out to sea yesterday. The sighting was made by Mrs. A. Johnson and Mrs. J. McMurrick.

Mrs. Johnson said the 'speck' appeared about the size of a tennis ball and that it was travelling "fairly fast" when they saw it about noon. "We saw it for about five minutes before it disappeared into low clouds", said Mrs. Johnson.

Auto Stops Due To Light In Sky.....

Manchester 1965 - These are the words of a former Manchester newsman now holding a position in Concord.

"I was driving on Rte 4-A between Wilmot and Enfield. The 10 p.m. news from WNAC was just starting on the car radio when all at once the radio stopped, the lights went out and the engine stopped!"

"I pulled to the side of the road (I was travelling about 60mph) to see what had happened and was still holding onto the door when I heard a very loud hum like a high-frequency electrical whine."

"I looked up and saw a very bright light which was below the cloud cover - I'd estimate it at between 2,000 and 5,000 feet - and looked about the size of a flashlight held at arm's length, pointed towards the face."

"It seemed to be hovering overhead for a moment and then took off south toward Mt. Cardigan, travelling very fast and went right across the red beacon light flashing on top of Mt. Cardigan."

"As the light left, the high pitched whine went away with it. When the whine died away my car's lights came on, the radio came on, and the motor started. The whole thing lasted about 20 seconds and there was no wind."

"I was more curious than anything else about the light and the sound...the thing that scared me the most was when the car started."

# GREAT UFO Sightings OF THE 60'S

No. 5 Illinois 1960


November 23, 1960: From 5 a.m. to 7:30 a.m., disc-shaped flying objects-- flying in formation, in pairs and singularly-- were seen by thousands of people as they toured the Midwest and Eastern states. A formation of UFOs was sighted at Midway Airport in Chicago. Airport tower controllers who saw the flying discs said: " We've never seen anything like it before and don't know what it was." The Federal Aviation Agency control center for Chicago said its personnel saw some mysterious bright craft in the sky " that didn't look like a meteor from those we've seen before." The control center in Chicago's O'Hare International airport was equally mystified. " Everybody has been getting reports on it, but we don't know what it was. I've never seen anything like it before. Its been reported all over--down south of here and in the east." That was the statement of a technician at O'Hare International airport.

Airline pilots and control tower operators spotted a formation at an altitude of 15,000 feet southeast of Chicago. Keith Muir, assistant chief of the Detroit Traffic Center, said members of his staff " picked up the objects on radar." Escal Bennet, in charge of the weather bureau in Cincinnati, Ohio, saw a formation at 6:22 a.m. " I know it was not a meteorological phenomenon. I had the definite feeling they were lifting or going up."

In Akron, Ohio, witnesses described the craft in formation as being circular, emitting cups of vapor which formed the letter C after discharge.

The majority of the observations on the 23rd were high altitude. However, many witnesses over an area from Missouri to New York reported spectacular saucer sightings at low altitude.

# Unidentified Flying Object Reported in Augusta County

FISHERSVILLE (AP)—If a huge unidentified flying object really did land in a field beside U. S. 250 in Augusta County, there's no trace of it now.

Horace Burns, a Grottoes gunsmith, reported sighting the object Dec. 21 while driving between Staunton and Waynesboro. "It was 125 feet in diameter, at least, and 80 to 90 feet high," Burns said.

A two-man air force team from Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Dayton, Ohio, checked the reported landing site with a geiger counter Tuesday and could find no indication of any unusual radiation count.

But Sgt. David Moody, who headed the team, did not rule out the possibility there had been radiation there earlier.

Ernest Gehman, a professor at Eastern Mennonite College, who heads a UFO investigators' club said he checked the site Dec. 30 with a geiger counter. "It knocked the thing (needle) off the dial," Gehman said, indicating a high concentration of radiation. He said his meter registered over 60,000 counts per minute.

Burns said the object made a "whooshing sound" and was shaped like an upside down ice cream cone. He said when it appeared in the sky his automobile engine quit running. He said he did not see any other automobiles on the highway.

Burns reported the object appeared to be made of spun aluminum or a similar material. Around the base was a bluish glow about a foot wide. It had no visible windows or doors, he said.

The object was on the ground for about a minute and a half, Burns reported. Then it suddenly rose perpendicularly for several hundred feet and took off in a northeasterly direction at a very fast speed.

## It Made Only a Soft 'Whooshing Sound'

A gunsmith who lives at Grottoes says he saw an unidentified flying object (UFO), similar to the object depicted above, late one afternoon last month. He said the UFO landed in a field alongside U. S. Rt. 250 near Fishersville in Augusta county, stayed for 60 to 90 seconds and then suddenly took off. It made only a soft 'whooshing sound,' said Horace Burns. It appeared to him to have been 80 to 90 feet high and about 125 feet in diameter. Burns' report was relayed to Ernest Gehman, an East-

ern Mennonite College professor who sponsors a UFO investigators' club there. Gehman made this drawing from descriptions given him by Burns. The sketch was prepared for reproduction by The Times-Dispatch staff artist. The sighting report was believed so unusual that a two-man investigation team from the air force plodded over the site Tuesday. The airmen found no indication that a UFO had been there.

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

## 'Boomerang' Lights Sky Over Ocean

A shimmering light variously described as "a yellow boomerang" and a "red star, only bigger" was spotted over Monterey Bay last night.

The sightings, one south of Carmel and the other at Santa Cruz, were reported about the same time as a Thor satellite was launched from Vandenberg Air Force Base. A sighting also was reported at San Diego.

The rocket was fired at 9:03 p.m. Monterey Sheriff's Lt. Henry Gilpin said he saw what looked "like a red star, only a little bigger" at about the same time. He said he was on Highway 1 south of Carmel.

He said he watched the light for 5 or 10 seconds.

Kenneth Marler, 1004 Broadway, Santa Cruz, told Santa Cruz County Sheriff's deputies he saw what appeared to be a "yellow boomerang" over the bay at 9:30 p.m.

## Clemens Sees Strange Sight In Sky: UFO?

Monterey Mayor George Clemens says he never believed in "unidentified flying objects" before, but now he's not so sure.

He happened to glance out of the window of his home about 6 p.m. yesterday and saw what appeared to be "a very bright star" in the northern sky.

He called his wife and son and together they saw the "star" perform the following acrobatics:

"It seemed to hover for awhile, then suddenly shot straight up at a very high speed for at least 500 feet.

"The glow began to fade, and the object dropped back down and hovered again, after which it dropped further down toward the water and disappeared."

The mayor said he could not tell whether it went into the ocean.

The Peninsula Airport tower says a light in the sky similar to that described by the mayor was seen low over the Presidio at about the same time.

The pilot of an airplane that was in the air at the time also reported seeing it and said it looked like "lightning."

The Coast Guard reported no sighting, and no calls were received by Peninsula police departments.

## Unidentified Objects Seen In Virginia

RICHMOND (UPI) — Unidentified flying objects (UFO) — from shiny inverted ice cream cones to zooming orange balls of light — have been plaguing Virginia skies for the past several days.

Yesterday evening, five Virginia Tech students reported a new one near Salem: an oblong with three yellow lights and one green light. This UFO hovered about 400 feet above the ground and kept pace with the students' car for some distance down a darkened highway.

IN RICHMOND, a radio newsman and his wife reported an orange ball of light streaking across the sky. The light "blinked out" on the horizon. It flew a straight path.

Two men driving near Williamsburg in separate cars told police they spotted a UFO near a highway intersection. It was described as tall, aluminum-coated and shaped like an inverted ice cream cone. It hovered 75 feet above the ground.

Both men said their car engines died during the few seconds the UFO was in view, but the cars started up again as soon as the object was out of sight.

IN VERONA, a couple reported a bright yellow light that hovered overhead for about five minutes before heading toward Staunton.

Three Buchanan County youngsters reported a circular UFO with three lighted ridges on its sides.

And in Augusta County, a man reported that three men, 36 inches tall, got out of two flying saucers, walked around a bit, then hopped back inside their vehicles and sneaked off.

## Pentagon Can't See Spots in Sky

According to Paul M. Dickey Jr. and Ed Shad, who were two of a dozen observers at those windows, there were 12 to 15 white, oval-shaped objects moving in erratic courses about 12,000 to 15,000 feet above Capitol Hill.

And they were being chased by two jet planes with delta wings. The sight was visible for several minutes, the men said.

The Defense Department, which has been up to its ears in reports of unidentified flying objects so long that the things are now known by initials, UFO, said simply:

"There was no such incident. It just didn't happen."

Nevertheless, Dickey and Shad and three other communications systems specialists employed by the Army—Sam Webb, Jack McBride and Sam Marrone—are convinced they saw what they think they saw.

They agree on the shape and approximate number of the discs and the fact that the things were speeding faster than the jet interceptors.
