The morning of April 24, 1965., dawned bright and sunny here in New England. It is a day that shall forever reign uppermost in my memory.....

At 9:25 A.M., I received a phone call from our good friend - Mrs. Alice Pomeroy. The first few words of the conversation, we had that morning, are burned into my memory; and are put down here exactly as they transpired.....

" Good morning, Joe. - Isn't it a beautiful morning? "

Hello, Alice. - Yes, it certainly is beautiful.

" It must be a beautiful morning to be landing on the planet Saturn....."

Yes...I imagine so.....

" Well Joe...I think that's where we might find Mr. Adamski this morning.....he left this life,..last night.....! "

The last time I saw and talked with Mr. Adamski, I shook his hand and said the words I wish to repeat here for the final time. It is fitting and proper, that I do.....

" Mr. Adamski...farewell and Godspeed."

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

On page sixteen of "Flying Saucers Farewell", George Adamski states....." Other signals seemed to be coming from open space, an unexplainable and unbelievable state of affairs, unless one took space vehicles into consideration. Not only did these signals continue for several months, they are still being received!"

...The skeptics laughed the world over. And then, in 1964, and again in 1965, the laughs were drowned out by an announcement from Russian astronomers, that radio signals from another civilization in space had been received!

Mr. Adamski gave a little smile and quietly said....."I tried to tell you, but, you would not listen....."

In "Flying Saucers Have Landed", Adamski told of having met a man from the planet Venus. The skeptics laughed...but not for long...because...in November of 1959, scientists discovered water vapor in the atmosphere of Venus! In February, 1960, Dr. Edward G. Pendray, founder of the American Rocket Society said: "Venus may turn out to be a wonderful place to live. We don't know much about its surface, because we cannot see it. But it is about the same size as our Earth and nearer to the sun. It may be like 'Florida', all over." In December, 1964, a team of astrophysicists from John Hopkins University stated that the clouds surrounding the planet Venus are composed of water in the form of ice particles. (like Earth)

The team, headed by Dr. John Strong, concluded that the latest data confirmed earlier measurements by Dr. Strong showing the surface temperature to be close to minus degrees fahrenheit, with only a few degrees difference between the light and dark sides of Venus.

When asked about the Mariner II space probe and its reported findings that the surface temperature of Venus was 800 degrees fahrenheit; Dr. Strong stated..... "Interpretation of radio-telescope waves as an indication of temperature has neither been proven or universally accepted." The possibility of a source of oxygen and a previous discovery that its atmosphere contains carbon dioxide, indicates the likely-hood of life existing on Venus.

Mr. Adamski gave a little smile and quietly said....."I tried to tell you, but, you would not listen....."

In - "Inside The Spaceships", George Adamski stated that the inhabitants of the planet Venus enjoyed a healthier and longer life span than people on Earth. Well the skeptics laughed again.

Then...in January of 1960, Dr. Vincent Askey, then President-elect of the American Medical Association told his colleagues that it might soon be possible to control evolution. He stated that within 50 years, it might be possible to develop man into a being with perfect health, high intelligence and a life expectancy of 125 years. The skeptics quieted down and.....

When George Adamski stated that the moon has an atmosphere., you could hear the laughter of the skeptics.....until.....1959. In that year, a Russian rocket landed on the Moon and radioed back the information that it is enveloped by a belt of low-energy ionized gases. It was suggested by the Russian scientists that these gases resembled an atmosphere.

John Townsend, of NASA, said: "The detection of an ionosphere at a relatively high distance from the Moon means that the Moon has a definite atmosphere, a condition that a few scientists could only guess at before."

Mr. Adamski gave that knowing smile and quietly said....."I tried to tell you, but, you would not listen....."

The skeptics had a field day when Adamski said that the space people had informed him that our solar system has twelve planets, rather than nine, as previously believed. The laughter resounded the world over by skeptics.....but.....

In February, 1960, astronomers (Russian) announced that they confirmed the existence of another planet (IO) beyond Pluto, which was previously supposed to be the 'last' one in our solar system! One down...two...to go. And again.....

Mr. Adamski smiled and said....."I tried to tell you, but, you would not listen."

From "Inside The Space Ships", again, the space people tell Adamski that..."In numerous large craters of the Moon, which you see from Earth, you will notice some very large hangars."

...In the January issue of Sky and Telescope (1958), a statement is found on page 138....."In recent years, amateur astronomers have been paying increasing attention to lunar "domes", small rounded "hills" that are being observed in increasing numbers..."

These domes, white and symmetrical, have appeared in the craters of the Moon increasingly so that over 200 have now been charted! Adamski shook his head and worried.....for he tried to tell us...but we would not listen.....!

In describing his first look at outer space, while riding in a Venusian Scout Ship, Adamski stated: "I was amazed to see that the background of space is totally dark. Yet...there were manifestations taking place all around us, as though billions upon billions of fireflies were flickering everywhere, moving in all directions, as fireflies do." 

A man who says he has visited Venus and has had continuing contacts with people from outer space since 1952, visited Worcester today to talk about his interplanetary experiences.

George Adamski, 74, of Vista, Calif., who looks and acts younger than he is, insisted quietly today that there are "many, many" people from outer space living among us.

In fact, Adamski said, it has only been their presence which has prevented the destruction of Earth by a nuclear holocaust and he added that if it wasn't for them our space program would not be as advanced as it is.

**'You Might Be One'**

"They look and talk just like you, in fact you could be one of them — I don't know — with all the questions you're asking," Adamski said at the interview.

"I first made contact with them in 1952, and I had no intention of talking about it. You never would have heard of me if one of the six witnesses at our meeting — a scientist from Arizona — hadn't gone and blabbed to the press about it," he said.

"I didn't go for a ride that first time. I wasn't scared, I was just a little cautious, but then, afterwards I decided what did I have to lose — I was getting old — and I went for a ride in their ship," Adamski said.

**Self-Styled Visitor to  
Venus  
Touches Down Here****Didn't Stop Off at Moon**

According to Adamski, the people he rode in space with were from Venus. He said he visited that planet but was reluctant to talk about his experiences there. He says he hasn't been to the moon.

He said, however, that the general disbelief which confronts him from all but his followers doesn't affect him. "They criticized everybody who came up with something new," he said.

**Venus Has 50 States**

"You know," he said, "in 1956 I wrote a book called 'Inside Space Ships,' and I talked about the firefly effect that you get when you look out at space when you're traveling through it. Years later, John Glenn comes back and says the exact same thing."

Adamski said he does not believe that the people from outer space who live among us constitute a threat. "If they were a danger to us, it would have showed up since I first met them," he said.


He added that the citizens of Venus have a democracy similar to that of the United States, and that instead of having separate nations on that planet their government is made up of 50 odd states.

He indicated the people that he had met from Venus are benevolent types because he said they instructed him to warn the public and certain government officials about the threat of nuclear destruction.

**Seasoned Venustronauts**

"They're very intelligent, and an expression of their intelligence is that they've been traveling through space to our planet for hundreds of years," Adamski said.

He maintains he is far from being the only person on Earth who has met visitors from

outer space. "About 2,000 other people have had the same type of experience," he said.

Adamski, in town to appear on WTAG's "Live Wire" and who will lecture at the Little Theater at 8 p.m. tomorrow, is the author of four books, including one he coauthored with Winston Churchill's nephew, Desmond Leslie, called "Flying Saucers Have Landed."

**Useful Information**

He says much useful information can be gained from creatures from other planets which is why he has kept up his contacts since first meeting them.

"I never counted how many of them are here, but they're here," he said, and then seeming to indicate that he believes the angels who are mentioned in the Bible were actually outer space visitors, he paraphrased the Book of Hebrews, "we can entertain angels without being aware they are angels."

"But they aren't coming here for a conquest," he added reassuringly.

### THE ADAMSKI LECTURE

To express in words, what transpired on that fateful night, could be simply said: "just one of those things". But no, that will not satisfy the many people who attended Mr. Adamski's lecture to see and hear him speak about 'flying saucers'. Therefore, we will attempt to explain or clarify what went wrong.....

After a successful lecture on March 22 and 24 in Buffalo, New York., where each night hundreds of people had to be turned away due to the hall's full capacity of 900 people...Mr. Adamski was called to Washington D.C., regarding his UFO films. (Gene Duplantier attended that lecture...get SS&S for his comments!)

He had to cancel his lecture in Boston and decided to lecture, here, in Worcester via the sponsorship of The UFO And Science of Life Study Groups at the request of Alice B. Pomeroy of Northboro. ....It is no easy task to set up a lecture for a personality, then in the midst of such a procedure, have to re-arrange it in a different locale. Mrs. Pomeroy worked hard to make it possible at all!

The marquee in front of the auditorium..."Flying Saucers"...it simply read...with date of event sans nom! (without name of Mr. Adamski or words 'lecture') Wonderfull eh? Ah yes, so wonderful that some poor souls entered the theater... thinking...they were going to see a movie by that name..."Flying Saucers"!!

The house was filling up...the screen was set...Tibor Csapo was making last check-ups on his recording equipment...then it began.....

Mr. Adamski dwelled on the philosophy of life...comparing that of the planet Venus with Earth! (people expected saucers) Finally the movies of said saucers began to appear on the screen...only to stop suddenly due to a malfunction...and the film burned a bit. It was reset and started again. Portion of comments by George Adamski, following the reading of his letter at the Woonsocket meeting. (letter follows tape excerpts) The following is transcribed from Mr. Samuel S. Reynolds' tape recording of this meeting who also took the accompanying photographs. Mr. Reynolds is the Uxbridge, Mass., Manager of The Woonsocket Call.

Mr. Adamski was already speaking when taping began.....He was discussing the various pictures of UFO's.....

".....The public will not believe such things unless someone gets moving pictures of bodies (UFO's) because if you have a document like that then they can see the form of a ship...what it's like...so our scientists can judge with one - another.

Now the film comes up, while they can't kick it out, they haven't yet said that it was a fake...The Air Force in Washington did not say it was a fake.

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I was very much disturbed in that the Space Administration viewed it and, while not coming out and saying anything definite, led you to believe that they thought something of it. Keyhoe could not disprove it either, but they asked him and he turned around and said: I think that Adamski's books are all fictional. That's the last attack, you might say, I can't say anything different, so we tackle them all now.... now we tackle the politicians. Now I'm going to tell you something. I based it on this letter on my experience.

- Give us an idea of what happened -

When vice president Nixon was running for president...in order to get California.... they had to have a Republican governor. Governor Knight was then governor. So they made a deal. Congressman Knowland was to be elected to office as governor...Republican...Governor Knight was offered the senatorship if he would relinquish the office.

They made a deal...well, at that time I asked the - people the same thing I am asking now...and they went and wrote to the different ones and a lot of them sent their replies to me. So when the time of election came along...so that Governor Knowland could take Governor Knight's place, and then Governor Knowland would be pulling for Nixon, the whole state of California.

Well, I wrote to Nixon and Nixon went to the Air Force about that rotten paper they sent out and Knowland did the same thing. Well then, when the election was coming up, the people asked me (who to vote for) I told them they should make up their own minds...I didn't tell them who to vote for.

Then I wrote to Kennedy and I wrote to Nixon and asked them if they would stop and see me on their way to San Diego, or, I told them that I would even come and see

them. Well, Kennedy did stop. He stopped over. Kennedy was 100% for the space people. If he had lived he probably would have brought (friendly relationships) about by now. After the second election. The first time he couldn't have done it. But during the second one...for the third one he wouldn't get.

So, Nixon ignored the whole thing. So I told the people...now let your conscience be your guide...you've got your answer from your representatives. I'll really tell you the God's truth, the people in California... there are about 25,000 believers up there...one vote is enough to beat you...well with 25,000 they really beat the hell out of him. So we have an example of it already and we can use that whip...we don't want to be involved in politics, but we can use politics for the betterment of mankind without being politicians. - That's why I wrote that letter...when the pressure is brought to bear and they begin to realize the numbers there are against them.

- You say Kennedy was all out for the visitors? -

Yes, because you see Kennedy, two days before the inaugural speech came to California...when he made the speech he made this statement: "In defense of this planet and this system....." - The press did not forget that and when he had the first press conference they asked him about it. What do you mean 'Our way of life?'.... He said:"No, solar system!"

- What about the story that he was contacted? -

This story, I would say must be true because of the way he acted and then his making that hurry-up trip to Palm Springs, which wasn't really to Palm Springs...but to Edwards Air Base...it was a non-scheduled trip and his ship came in there and he went out there to think and to talk it over.

The same people contacted him as contacted the president of Mexico. The old president. Both were at the space conference when the space people told them what the score is.

If you had heard the former president of Mexico talk and did not see him, you would swear that it was a - space-man talking! Every darn thing that has ever come through the space people...he mentioned!



IT WAS A SPACEMAN TALKING!

This was carried over Mexican TV...not on American TV, but his speech was mentioned on the news. I listened to it all day long on Channels 6 and 12. Both Mexican stations which come in...in the San Diego County like our own stations do in color...beautiful...amazing...if I didn't see the man on the screen I would have said that it was a space man was talking, so you see in Mexico they are pretty well versed and they are a lot more liberal with this information than we are.

They don't have to borrow money from us...they are quite independent...every nation that gets money from us must make concessions...the Air Force says keep quiet about anything you see, and you have to be quiet. The trouble in Viet Nam is a religious war, and you see the prophecies are coming true...the colored races are rising to prominence and demanding their rights.

Have You Ever Brought A Visitor Before A Senate Sub - Committee?

No, but I think that the Senate Sub-Committee knows who the people are anyway, because a visitor was with all of the Presidents. Eisenhower, Truman, Kennedy, now he's with Johnson, he's like that, so I guess they know all about it. In fact, in the first term of Eisenhower there was a very fine looking man, beautiful structure, nearly a seven-footer...with him and President Eisenhower-it looked like Mutt and Jeff...he had really a wonderful physique, and in this picture President Eisenhower was handing him a scroll...and a number of people recognized him as a space man. And he was. He was handed a scroll and left the country for about two years on a mission for us. Hardly anyone knows who he is, but he is a space man.

I can also tell you that we have given 35mm film in the early days to a space man...and a camera...to take to Venus to photograph the cities in color. And I know the girl who was the inspector on that film and she brought a Navy Commander of a battle wagon...that his ship followed from the south seas island to San Diego port...and left him within 15 miles of San Diego Base.

She brought him up to our place...she brought him up purposely because he wanted to know what kind of people were on this ship. I told him and I mentioned this film and she said, I know it is so, I was the inspector on that. When she said this he looked at her, he must have known too. - The way he looked at her...she turned white. I've never seen that girl again. They then left...they didn't finish their food or anything.

What About The Three Men In Black? - Do You Know Who They Are?

The three men in black, portrayed as though they were space people...the trouble is that Bender was frightened or maybe paid off...even to say what he'd seem. The whole thing is false.

Those were men of this world, not space people...what would they be doing that for...they came here to alert us and then they were trying to stop us from talking? - It does'nt make sense. - But he was shut up.

I had worse conditions than that, but I wasn't Bender...we are taking my case to court...it's in the hands of my attorney. Sure I was frightened. When they threaten you with worse conditions than the Gestapo ever did...frightening... I prepared this document because my attorney told me to write it up and send it to my friends in Europe. Some opened the letters, others published some of it in the early days. Some left the letters unopened. I sent one to myself.

When I wrote the last book they refused to publish it here...they said it was too hot...I put it all in there. I didn't name the men, I just called them - X 1, 2, and 3. I didn't want to let the people know, because I still want to live here. We went to Takarti, that's a place on the border, that was the place my attorney told me about...usually my secretary stayed home...my wife then was living. She begged me to give this thing up...she didn't want to die that way and my wife, Alice and myself, went to Takarti looking for a hole in the border through which to jump without any papers if I had to.

The attorney told me that, in the meantime I had a program, a panel job on channel 10, and I had to cancel that and they were going to sue us for not carrying the program when it was all set up. Lucy, the secretary, argued with them over the phone. They told her to send a wire and get me back or there would be a lawsuit against me. But I was stalling for time to hear what the attorney was going to say...she knew we were coming back.

The attorney finally said that it was all-right to go on the channel 10 panel job...provided they let me tape what was to be said. We went there an hour early. When these three fellows came up there on a Thursday, they said: the next time you come down here we will drag you down to San Diego behind this car...we don't care what happens to you...your life don't mean a thing to us. I said...well look, there are people coming up here, what am I to say when they ask questions? - Tell them you are not at liberty to answer. Okay, so I kept that (on tape)... I was beating them to the punch a little bit.

Well Seymour Francis and another fellow who is now a congressman in Washington, he was elected in the last election there, were both newspapermen...got the story and they didn't like it. A newspaperman from Washington was also on the panel. Seymour Francis asked me questions and I told him I was not at liberty to answer. Then they started out...they knew the story...what I wanted to say they said for me...and we busted into a hornet's nest like nobody's business.

So a call came in, while we were on the air, asking why I didn't bring a witness? The answer was that a witness was there while the program was being taped. The fellow that was in charge of this whole darn affair made such a mess out of it... because it was all over the air.

Meantime, my attorney was trying to pull them into court, but they would not appear in court because that would be a dead give-away. So they dropped the thing...and the one who was in charge was transferred out of his district of San Diego County...was gone two years...and is back there now, but he is not bothering me.

I was frightened what they might do to me...but at the same time I was not giving in. I am pretty stubborn that way. So, I said, after all this is the United States and there are still courts so I put it in my attorney's hands to see what could be done, so he went at them.

When he found that I put things into my attorney's hands, instead of shutting up, and was determined to fight it he was about ready to pull me into court and on top of that I went on the air and more or less exposed them to what was going on.

So, I know the score of the three men in black...so Bender was either a coward or else he was paid off. I don't know.

.....I have six thick scrapbooks to hold the clippings which came out in the early days. Commander McMillan was talking plain. Because of that they sent him out to sea for six months...away from his wife. They broke him and he is now as silent as a rabbit.

I haven't perverted anything, that's why I have a contact here. Naturally, when I make a first contact, that is only to get acquainted.

There's going to be information coming all along from all the contactees..... they're supposed to be contactees.....maybe they won't contact them anymore, but I am being contacted right along."

Many other questions were asked by us which dealt with saucer propulsion...life on the Moon, Venus, Mars, etc. He showed us photos...some taken of the Moon by NASA...also of space taken from a U.S. Capsule...which were very interesting to a point of awe. Needless to say, these photos are not available to the general public! (we cannot get any either)

A wonderfull and enlightening evening was enjoyed tremendously by all!

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Way back when...a few months ago...I had given serious consideration to bringing George Adamski to the lower Worcester County...Woonsocket, Rhode Island area for a public speaking engagement; I had made plans for a group to host him. A supper before the talk at which he could meet those with a genuine interest and then a couple of hours of talk afterwards.

But I decided to call the whole thing off. The reason was not George Adamski. The reason was people and their basic cruelty. I did not know George Adamski then - he was just another of the parade of people, since my first contact with a contactee back in college, who claimed to have talked with and visited space people.

On the inside chance that he might be legitimate I did not think it wise to expose him to a room full of closed minds. I felt that the opportunity to listen to him, and study him while he spoke, would arise someday, and I did not want to spoil him for this.

When the word got around the Saturday afternoon following his Woonsocket visit, that I had been granted this privilege, along with my wife, the general comment was: "Gee, for a newspaper guy you sure go for way-out things." And "boy, I bet you tore him limb from limb."

Yes, if the new science is way-out, then my wife and I are as far out as you can get without blasting into orbit. We try to keep open minds on all matters.... science...philosophy...religion...etc.

No, I didn't tear him limb from limb. In fact those who were there probably will recall that I had very little to say to Adamski other than passing the time of day. But Adamski did not escape from my grasp.

First, he has a very noticeable nervous habit of interjecting "see" every few phrases...he has a strong wish to be understood, not merely listened to.

Secondly, his mind seems to be crowded with much to say, and despite the fact he came to this country at the age of three, he has a slight accent which sometimes is overpowering for those trying to fathom what he is saying at a mile-a-minute rate. I think that he realizes this, thus the "see" interjection.

Thirdly, he is a talker who must lean heavily on his cigarette. Nervous, he fondles a cigarette as much as he smokes it. Yet, he watches people as he talks. Many times he reached across me (I don't smoke) to offer my wife a light for her cigarette...and note this...many times the lighter was on its way into service before my wife had begun to reach for her pack of smokes!

Fourthly, there is something about the man...his manner, his voice...not hypnotic, but there is something there which erases any hostile emotion. I had no intention of being hostile, but I feel that if I had wished to become hostile, I could not have done so. You explain it...maybe Adamski falls into that broad class of sweet people whom you cannot hurt. (some people don't go along with this)

Fifthly, in his delivery I noted that during certain phases of his accounts of happenings, especially where he was subjected to pressure from official circles, his voice quavers, he becomes more nervous and his rate of breathing seems to increase. This is not a theatrical emotion, but is very subtle. You have to look closely to see it, but it's there.

Sixthly, and finally, he seems to be aware of what you are thinking...he looked at me and answered questions which I did not ask...but of which I was thinking...he gave a little twinkle to his eye when he did so. You can draw your own conclusions to this latter point, I have mine, but I hoard it until later. (continued.....)

Let us travel down one avenue opened by Adamski.....

He said that there are thousands of space people here on earth, but that there are only a handful of contactees. Thus with all of these people from out there mixed in with the population down here, there must be at least a few which each of us have come in contact with unknowingly.

These, too, are human, according to Adamski, just as we are, and must be subject to some of the emotions which we enjoy. What happens when a space person meets an especially attractive earthling? Was that good-looking girl who went out of your life a space person? Or, is that rather bright person you married one of them? Let us go off on a tangent for a moment for an odd fact.....

Did you know that the blood of a St. Bernard dog mixes with that of the smallest Mexican hairless? Big dogs are kept in animal hospitals as donors for dogs which must undergo surgery? There seems to be no blood type or Rh factor to foul up things in the operating room? How come we have blood types...A, B, AB and O...? (and maybe a few more) Plus an Rh positive and negative factor to complicate matters in the operating room? How long has there been a difference in the human blood types? Could they have developed from inter-marriage between human stock from here and there? - A few years ago it was noted that the appendix is disappearing! The little fingers are getting shorter! Wisdom teeth are getting out of style...and...the amount of hair on fingers and body varies greatly!

Now...let us suppose that you have married a person from out there. Why doesn't he or she tell you? Could it be that they do not know this? Could it be possible that the key to such knowledge may be locked up inside the descendants of the space people, only to be triggered when the proper time arrives? If it doesn't arrive...the person expires...never realizing his or her potential mission...but would this unknown factor be passed on to all...or...certain offspring...?

Thus if they don't know who they are, how are we to know who we are? We don't! Could it be possible that we here on earth might be the near final result in a galactic experiment in evolution and animal husbandry? Suppose that you were a scientist in a society which had mastered space travel and all of the other luxuries of science-fiction writers...where could you next turn? Where did you come from?

Remember the Herrmann poltergeist case in Seaford?

For five hectic weeks, a thoroughly normal, quite religious family was bewildered and badgered by a string of weird, wild, seemingly supernatural "happenings."

Bottles popped their tops, solid objects flew through the air and strange rappings were heard in the neat, modern, six-room ranch house at 1648 Redwood Path.

Nassau's police haven't forgotten. The case will stay in their unsolved file until they find solid proof of

whether something human or inhuman caused the events that started on Feb. 3, 1958.

That was the afternoon Mrs. Herrmann came home before her school-age youngsters and found a half-dozen screw-top bottles had opened and toppled over—apparently by themselves — in four different rooms.

Other bottles unscrewed their lids and tipped over. The rappings grew more frequent. James Herrmann, the head of the house, watched stunned as two bottles moved themselves across a bathroom shelf and shattered on the floor before his eyes.

He called for police help.

The case went to a shrewd, well-trained detective, Joseph Tozzi.

He literally lived day and night with the family, eventually writing the most complete, accurate report ever compiled of one of these strange events so common for centuries in folklore.

AFTER 18 days of these unnerving events, the Herrman family fled to a nearby relative's house for 48 hours.

Things were no better when they came home.

Tables tipped over in the living room. Jimmy's solid bedroom bureau crashed to the floor twice. An ink bottle took off from the dining room table and shattered against a wall.

A foot-high world globe twice flew the length of Jimmy's room, crossed a hallway and landed in the living room.

A 12-pound portable phonograph soared 16 feet across a basement playroom, making a hefty gash in a knick-knack shelf.

Long Island Lighting Co. technicians made vibration tests with delicate instruments. RCA experts used a truckload of equipment to look for radio waves that might be the cause. Hempstead Town building inspec-

tors combed the house for structural defects.

They all found nothing.

On March 10, with parapsychologists and Det. Tozzi still on the scene, one object flew. The family heard rapping that seemed to come from a wall.

They didn't know it then, but that was the last gasp of the natural or supernatural source of their troubles.

# ADRIFT IN OCEAN FOR 17 HOURS EX-PARATROOPER DOESN'T PANIC—GOES TO SLEEP INSTEAD

When ex-paratrooper Don McNeal was tossed from the cockpit of a tiny sailboat during a fierce storm, he knew he was in serious trouble.

But he also knew that the first rule to remember in such a situation is: Don't panic.

So he relaxed.

And he did such a good job of it that for much of the 17 hours that he was adrift, he slept soundly and comfortably in the storm-tossed sea.

McNeal's ordeal started on Jan. 4 when a friend, Dr. Charles T. Spencer, invited him out for a sail. McNeal, a veteran swimmer and skin-diver, accepted even though the weather off Miami, Florida looked bad.

Not far off the Florida coast, a sudden squall cap-sized the 21-foot sloop and both men were flung into the raging sea.

Spencer managed to climb back aboard. But McNeal was weighed down by the heavy clothes he wore, and

the boat drifted off into the darkness.

"I thought I could catch up with the boat," McNeal said. "But I couldn't get there fast enough, and it drifted away."

So he had to start swimming for his life.

"I stripped off all my clothes except my T-shirt," McNeal said. "It's a good thing the water was warm."

"Then I swam towards a spot where I knew ship passed regularly. I was hoping one of the freighter going into Miami would spot me."

But none did. McNeal drifted—and found himself dozing.

"I knew I should stay awake," McNeal said. "But I couldn't. I kept dozing off."

"However, I somehow managed to keep my hands and feet moving even though I was dozing, and that kept me afloat."

Finally, 17 hours after he was washed overboard, a boat from Miami spotted his head bobbing in the water.

By that time McNeal was sleeping so soundly he didn't even hear the boat arrive. He woke up as he was being hauled aboard.

Doctors at a Miami hospital said he has come through his terrible ordeal very well. His only injury was a swelling of the eyes because of salt water, they said.

# THE CASE - OF - THE DEAD RINGER

Chicago police Friday asked federal help in solving the mystery of a dead ringer. Lawrence Joseph Bader, 31, disappeared while motorboating alone on storm-tossed Lake Erie on May 17, 1957. He has been presumed dead for more than seven years. Insurance has been paid to his wife and four children. Last Thursday, during a sports show at Mc-Cornick Place, a friend of the Bader family saw a man wearing a black patch over one eye. He looked like Larry Bader — or his ghost. The man denied it. He identified himself as John (Fritz) Johnson of Omaha, a television announcer.

## Persuaded To Talk On Phone

The friend was insistent. He persuaded Johnson to talk on the phone to the Bader family in Akron, Ohio. On the basis of the sound of his voice, two brothers, Richard and John A. Bader, flew to Chicago.

They positively identified Johnson as their "dead" brother.

Johnson amiably denied it. He said he had a wife and children in Omaha. He had lost his eye to cancer, he explained. He volunteered to have his fingerprints taken. Larry Bader's prints were on file in Washington from Navy service. Johnson commented that he, too, had been in the Navy.

Police directed the Baders and Johnson to the identification section in police headquarters at 1121 S. State.

The fingerprints were taken Thursday night and sent, airmail-special delivery, to Washington. They had not been processed Friday.

## Prints Taken, They Leave

After the prints were taken, the men left together. "I'll buy you supper," said Johnson. The Bader brothers subsequently returned to Akron. Contacted there Friday night, they declined further comment. Johnson presumably returned to Omaha but could not be reached.

Because of the uniqueness of the case, Chicago police called the Federal Bureau of Investigation and supplied the numerical "formula" derived from their reading of the prints.

Perhaps 100 sets of prints are filed under each formula, experts said. Johnson and "Lawrence Joseph Bader, USN, Cleveland, Ohio, 30 Nov. 1944" both were listed in the same formula category.

Bader, a successful kitchenware salesman, called his wife, Mary Lou from his office to say he was going fishing.

He traveled the 33 miles to Cleveland and made several attempts to rent a boat. He was turned down because of small-craft warnings against a storm. He persisted and finally rented a 14-foot, outboard boat and went out on the lake.

That was the last time he was seen.

The boat was found adrift, empty, after a Coast Guard search. Bader's fishing tackle was identified by members of his family. His wife gave birth to their fourth child four months later.

It was not until May, 1964—seven years after the disappearance—that his insurance policy was paid.

At about the same time Bader disappeared, John Johnson arrived in Omaha and went to work as an announcer for Station KETV.

A check with the station revealed that Johnson has worked there "about eight years" and said he was an orphan and Navy veteran.

The station secretary said she had worked there

a short time, and didn't know much about his background. She did know, however, that he was an archery enthusiast and she thought he was Nebraska champion. He had traveled to the Chicago sports show because of his interest in archery she said.

In a phone conversation from police headquarters Richard had said to an unidentified person in Ohio, "It's the most remarkable thing I've seen in my life. . . . I don't know what to tell you."

Johnson said he wanted to help the Bader brothers and the police in every way he could but continued his denials. He told interrogators that he had forgot nothing of his background. He knew he was not Larry Bader, he said.

Just as surely, the brothers insisted he was.

A veteran police identification expert was inclined to believe the brothers. When tentative fingerprints identification was added to the other eight points, he said:

"If this is another coincidence, Ripley wouldn't believe it."

A nurse and an attendant recognized the girl and called her parents to the hospital.

Mr. and Mrs. Robert O. Younkin tearfully identified the body and initiated funeral arrangements.

Returning home, Younkin called Kathy's boy friend, Martin Grimes, who had dropped Kathy off at the apartment of a girl friend after their Friday night date. Martin went to the Younkin house. He broke down.

"I asked him what time he dropped her off," Younkin said. "He said about 1 a.m. I asked him what she was wearing. He said a skirt and blouse. I said: 'The hell you say, she was in tight jeans.'"

Younkin called the girl friend's apartment, and Kathy was there.

"We saw Kathy at the hospital," Younkin said later. "We touched her hands and her face. We touched her body from head to toe. We saw her four times."

"I'm not trying to dramatize the thing. I'm just trying to say that everything was perfect. This was our daughter. Kathy has two small fingers that aren't exactly straight. This girl's fingers were just like Kathy's."

The dead girl eventually was identified as Gretchen C. Wells, 19. Kathy had lost her driver's license. She has no idea how it got in Gretchen's purse. The girls did not know each other.

# Mysterious Lights Flash Over Sydney

Bright, fast-moving unidentified objects flashed across the sky last night and startled hundreds of people in Sydney and throughout N.S.W.

They crossed the State from north-west to south-east, passing over Coonabarabran, Kandos and finally Sydney.

Sightings came also from many parts of the central west, including Orange, Molong and Bathurst.

The objects shot across the State between 7.45 p.m. and 8 p.m., and an estimated 200 callers immediately jammed the "Herald" switchboard reporting "white heads and long red tails."

An Orange man, Mr K. McIntosh, who took sightings on the lights, said they appeared to be travelling at between 18,000 and 20,000 miles an hour.

The course was consistent with that followed by Russian satellites.

Mrs L. Ford, of Donoghue Street, Kandos, said: "They appeared to be like meteors.

"As they flew across the south-east, they appeared to break up."

Mr and Mrs E. Williams, of 18 May Street, Hornsby, said they saw four to six

lights flashing across the sky as though they were running along invisible wires.

Mr R. J. Morris, of Pacific Highway, Mount Colah, said that he saw the lights travelling towards the city, in "formation."

"The lights looked like small comets—they were coloured yellow, with short trails which looked like sparks," he said.

"They appeared to be a lot higher than the altitude at which airliners fly."

Mr H. Richardson, of Leppington, said: "It was a weird sight. No sound, just a steady movement of eight lights in close formation. Too fast for planes and too slow for a meteor. I just couldn't make anything of them."

Spokesmen for the Civil Aviation Department and R.A.A.F. Air Traffic Control, at Mascot, said they also received many reports of lights flying at high speed over Sydney.

"We did not see them but we can definitely say that no R.A.A.F. or civil planes were flying

in group formation as the light-sighting reports indicated," they said.

The lights passed almost overhead as 50 members of the Astronomical Society of N.S.W. were meeting at Belfield Observatory.

The director of the observatory, Mr Gordon Patston, said later that all the amateur astronomers had seen the lights, and dozens more people had telephoned about them.

Mr Patston said the lights, of which most observers counted about eight, were seen 30 degrees above the horizon 25 degrees west of north.

Each object seemed to have a long, red incandescent tail about 20 times the length of the head of the object.

## Observed for 30 Seconds

They disappeared at a level well above the horizon, but when the first one disappeared, the last was 50 degrees behind it.

The period of observation was about 30 seconds.

# OBJECTS SIGHTED IN SKY

By A Staff Reporter

The Bureau of Meteorology and "The Advertiser" switchboards were swamped with telephone calls early yesterday evening from people seeing things in the sky.

Said a desperate bureau spokesman: "As if hot nights weren't bad enough, we get all this information from lucky people sitting in deck chairs, lying on beaches and lawns gazing up at the sky watching meteors, Boeing 727s, satellites and assorted space-probe hardware milling around up there."

Most of the people who telephoned reported seeing objects at all points of the compass and at elevations ranging from a few degrees above the horizon to directly overhead.

"There are now about 500 man-made objects whirling around in space and a lot of it is Russian booster material on which we have no data," the spokesman said.

## Death Plunge

However he agreed that at least three people might have seen, and at least one of them heard, the death plunge of a large mass of booster material into the atmosphere above SA.

Mr. Graham Hancock, a schoolteacher, of Blinman, with the local police officer, Constable J. Greet, reported watching an object for about three minutes at an elevation of 60 degrees, moving from the north-west and dipping towards the south-east.

Mr. W. H. Thompson, of Kangarilla, a former RAF wireless operator-air gunner, also reported seeing a similar orange-colored object about the same time (7.30 p.m.) and on the same track.

He said he saw it dip to an elevation of about 35 degrees then disintegrate, leaving an orange trail.

About five minutes later there was a distinctly audible sound "like a clap of thunder," Mr. Thompson said.

The Bureau of Meteorology confirmed that there was no possibility of thunderstorm activity in the area at the time.

# Experts Say Fireball Is Not a Satellite

CAMBRIDGE (AP) — The Smithsonian Astrophysical Observatory has tentatively identified a bright fireball seen east of Vancouver, B.C., Wednesday night as "a shower of meteorites" and not a returning satellite.

The Smithsonian yesterday said a volunteer team of Canadian observers working under its auspices spotted the fireball during a watch for the American "Starflash" 48—a satellite launched in August, 1964, from Vandenberg Air Force Base, Calif.

A spokesman for the observatory said, "primarily we don't think it was the satellite be-

cause the flash was too bright."

The fireball was seen over a large area of western Canada and the Pacific, he said, and a Canadian commercial airline pilot reported the flash "lit up the whole sky."

"Satellites usually don't come in that fast to generate enough heat to light up the sky," the spokesman said.

No reports have been received of the re-entry of the 48-A, which was due to return Wednesday or Thursday, he said. The spokesman said he did not know what job the satellite was performing in space.


A spokesman for the Air Safety office at Takamatsu on Shikoku Island said the planes were a Convair 240 airliner and a private Piper Apache plane.

The object was immense even from a great distance, Mrs. Wennersten said. It remained in view but two or three seconds, and disappeared.



## Navy Probes Sighting Of Sub In St. Lawrence

QUEBEC (CP)—The navy is investigating the reported sighting of an unidentified submarine in the St. Lawrence Monday night by the pilot of a Quebecair passenger flight.

RCMP here said the investigation has been turned over to the navy, which had not had reports of Canadian or United States submarines being in the river at that time.

An RCMP spokesman said the radio tower at L'Ancienne Lorette airport here received a report from Pilot Claude Laurin at 5:40 p.m. Monday saying he had "sighted a submarine going down the St. Lawrence River in a northeasterly direction between the main channel and Ile-aux-Coudres."

When the pilot went down to investigate, "the submarine quickly submerged," the RCMP report said.

The sighting was made five to seven miles northeast of Ile-aux-Coudres, which lies close to the north shore of the river. At this point the St. Lawrence is about 20 miles wide and is be-

ginning to broaden for its entry into the sea.

In Montreal, Capt. Laurin said today the submarine was not completely surfaced when he spotted it.

The 30-year-old pilot, who has been with Quebecair for nine years, said the craft bore no marks and was "a big enough ship."

"We kept her in sight for four or five minutes and then, with 22 passengers aboard my plane, I had to continue on to Quebec City."

The sub had its snorkel breathing apparatus and part of its conning tower above water at the time.

Capt. Laurin said his co-pilot also saw the submarine.

HALIFAX (CP) — A navy spokesman said today the navy's Atlantic Command had received a report of a submarine sighting in the St. Lawrence River, but said "it could not possibly have been a submarine because the location was in an area where a submarine could not operate."

## REPORTS NINE COSMONAUTS LOST IN SPACE

ROME, March 14—One of two Italian brothers who keep radio tabs on Russian-manned space shots said today the Soviets have lost at least nine cosmonauts in space since 1960.

Giovanni Judica - Cordiglia, who with his brother, Achille, operates a listening post in Turin, said that United States officials believe 14 cosmonaut launchings have ended disastrously. The Italian said he and his brother picked up mes-

sages from nine spaceships that did not return to earth.

Giovanni was moved to comment by a story in today's Corriere Della Sera in Milan which detailed the misfired space shots. The newspaper reported the names of five lost cosmonauts and said two, Sciboting and Dolgob, died with a woman explorer in May, 1964. The others named, and their flight dates, were: Zovodoski, October, 1961; Lodovsky, October, 1962, and Belokonev, November, 1962. Russia has always denied losing any of its cosmonauts.

## 'I Stared Back...' Man Recounts Run-In With 'Saucer, Robot'

BROOKSVILLE (TPD)—"It made a whistling noise and went straight up at 5,000 miles an hour or even faster," retired longshoreman John F. Reeves said yesterday in describing a flying saucer he claims to have stumbled onto while on a walk in the woods near here.

Reeves, who admits to being "past 60," told a story Wednesday of coming onto the "flying saucer" in the woods between here and Weeki Wachee on Tuesday afternoon and of a robot-type creature that appeared to take his picture.

**REEVES, WHO LIVES ALONE** at a trailer park west of here, told of breaking through some bushes about a mile and three-quarters off Highway 50 at mid-afternoon and seeing the flying saucer about 700 yards away.

He said he worked his way to within about 100 feet of the object when the robot-type creature appeared and walked toward him, stopping less than 15 feet away.

Reeves said the robot wore a gray canvas-type suit with a glass dome helmet. He described it as being about 5-feet tall and stocky.


"He walked over to within 15 feet of me and looked right at me," Reeves said. "I stared back at his glass dome."

He described the creature as appearing to have dark tan flesh, and added that everything except the face was covered. He said it had eyes farther apart than a normal human's and had a more pointed chin.

"**IT DIDN'T MAKE A SOUND**, it just stared at me," he said.

"I couldn't even blink an eye I was so scared."

Reeves said the creature then lifted what he believes

to have been a camera to chin level, pointed it at him and it flashed.

"He flashed again and I took off from the bushes," Reeves said.

Reeves said the creature flashed a third time and then returned and entered the machine. He said the thing that flashed was black and about six to seven inches in diameter.

The flying saucer was described as 20 to 30 feet in diameter and six feet high and stood on a four-legged landing gear.

"It was bluish-green and reddish-purple in color with two windows on top," Reeves said.

Reeves said he saw only one robot and it dropped two pieces of cloth-like paper as it headed back to the saucer. Reeves said he retrieved the papers and they had "very queer writing" on them.

"**THEY WERE FROM** outer space," he said.

He said that after the robot entered the machine, some blades on the rim started to move like venetian blinds, working open and shut.

"Then the rim started going around counterclockwise," Reeves said. "It made a whistling and rumbling noise and then started straight up. It was out of sight in 10 seconds."

Reeves said he walks through the woods in this West Central Florida area often and this was the first time he had seen or heard anything unusual.

The two pieces of paper were turned over to an investigating team from MacDill Air Force Base in Tampa.

**OFFICIALS AT MacDILL** said the investigation is a routine one made whenever any "aerial phenomenon" is reported. The Air Force team talked to Reeves and visited the wooded area.

The base said the team will send its report directly to Project Bluebook at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Dayton, Ohio.

## Sonic Booms Startle Wide Area

A pair of massive sonic booms rattled windows and startled thousands of residents in the Worcester area and as far east as Framingham at about 11:45 last night.

Bar patrons in Leominster ran into the streets to gaze skyward. Hundreds of calls deluged switchboards at police headquarters in a score of cities and towns.

In Clinton, a woman thought her furnace had exploded and telephoned Rev. G. David White, pastor of Church of the Good Shepherd, for assistance.

The booms were heard as far north as Ayer and as far south as Milford. Police cruisers scurried about communities checking "explosion" reports.

Shortly after midnight the duty officer at Hanscom Air Force Base in Bedford confirmed that the blasts were sonic booms. He said personnel there had been tracking a jet on radar "for some time" but that they didn't know what base it came from.

**Dr. Franklin M. Branley**, an astronomer at New York's Hayden Planetarium, said in an interview there is no question that "there are people out there" in outer space and predicted that some day contact would be established between them and inhabitants of earth.

inating organizations ever to own a gavel, the New England Unidentified Flying Object Study Group. Mrs. Elizabeth Chorney, 35, of 2 Griffin rd. revealed her bizarre story for the first time publicly.

### CIGAR-SHAPED OBJECT

It happened on the night of April 1, shortly before 10 p. m. as she and her son, Steven, 14, were returning home from the library.

"It was an amazingly clear night," Mrs. Chorney said. "Just before we got home, I looked up into the sky and saw a cigar-shaped object, not more than 100 yards in the air.

"It had four windows and a red light flashed from its rear. The light was alternately very bright, and then quite dim. There was no sound at all com-

ing from it.

"I watched it for about 35 minutes, during which time it traveled very slowly in what looked like a letter 'S' course. When it was approximately over Lowell, I noticed three smaller cigar-shaped objects off to the right. They seemed to be standing still, but when the larger object came into view they joined it immediately. Then all four disappeared in the distance.

### MRS. CHORNEY'S SEEN 16

"Shortly after they were out of sight, I saw seven Air Force planes in the area. I imagined they were from Hanscom Field in Bedford. They seemed to be searching."

Mrs. Chorney claimed that since 1960, when she first became interested in sky-watching, she has seen 16 unidenti-

fied objects and in a number of cases Air Force planes came into the area shortly after the sightings.

She added that after the latest incident three different persons told her they saw the very same objects. According to the records of the Study Group, only one other "cigar-shaped" sighting has been reported and that was in Panama in 1947.

Mrs. Chorney was one of 100 who attended yesterday's annual meeting of the Group. She reportedly will send a description of the sighting to the National Investigating Committee on Aerial Natural Phenomenon.

## THE AUSTRALIAN 'Please don't shoot at the flying saucers'

February 26, 1965

Scientific experts from all Australian States and New Zealand plan to petition the Federal Government to make public that it is collecting information on unidentified flying objects.

A three-day conference, sponsored by the Australian Flying Saucer Research Society, opens at Ballarat, Victoria, today.

The petition asks that, "as there is considerable evidence that some unidentified flying objects are manned, orders be given to defence forces not to shoot at them.

"The objects should be treated with respect," the petition says, "and their occupants given a friendly welcome."

It was unlikely that "the visiting space travellers would land and share their technical knowledge with a world divided and armed for war."

The RAAF's senior research scientist, Mr R. Roberts, will lecture at the conference at which at least four delegates, ac-

cording to the vice-president of the Australian Flying Saucer Research Society of South Australia Mr Colin Norris, will give evidence of sighting objects.

### HUMAN-LIKE

Mr Norris named three clergymen who said they saw manned "saucers" in New Guinea. They had made visual contact with some "human-like" beings.

Also, a farmer had sighted a flying saucer as it hovered 75 feet above his property near Melbourne last year.

The vibrations from the saucer's "engines," which could not be heard by humans, had disturbed the farm animals.

The farmer had been visited by officers from the CSIRO and confirmed that after seeing the saucer he suffered a violent headache.

The CSIRO had attributed the headache to the saucer's supersonic vibrations.

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IO YEARS AFTER DEATH PARKER'S JAZZ LIVES.....

Ten years ago Charlie Parker was supposed to be at Boston's Storyville to play his alto saxophone.....He never made it.....

Bird, as he will always be known, died in a baroness' apartment at the Stanhope Hotel at 5th av., and 81st Street in New York on March 12, 1955.

Confusion and uncertainty, which had been so much a part of this jazz musicians life, were present at his death. His body was removed to the Bellevue Hospital morgue where it was properly identified.

Apparently a mixup came when no one made it immediately known that this was the body of Charles Parker, the jazz musician.

A doctor attributed death to a heart attack and cirrhosis of the liver. ....Later, a medical examiner said, an autopsy disclosed that death was due to lobar pneumonia!

Charlie Parker was nearly 35 when he died...but...one doctor estimated his age at 53! - And, another doctor, at ...60!! - He had lived a turbulent life and so perhaps in those final hours...a frantic 35 years suddenly took its toll.

Parker was born at 852 Freeman Street in Kansas City, Kansas on August the 29, 1920.

SOVIET SPACE SIGNALS

It could be that the second person of the Blessed Trinity assumed the nature of rational beings of another world, as well as human nature on earth. Or, one of the other Divine Persons could have become Incarnate on another planet.

A final major possibility mentioned by Fr. Connell, is that, these beings could have been created 'in a purely natural state,' without any supernatural gifts and with merely a natural, but eternal destiny." (Catholic Free Press 4/19/65)

Out of a thousand-million stars with possible planetary systems, and the many theoretical aspects of Fr. Connell, is it not then possible that we have many different types of people visiting us? Various shaped vehicles unknown to u. continue to be observed in our skies.

Concerning the clipping, "Mystery Object Buzzes Planes", (page I7) sent in to us by our Representative K E N N E T H H O M A N of New Jersey; the following letter was received by him, and forwarded to us, in answer to his query.....

Takamatsu Aeronautical Aids Office  
Hayashi-cho, Takamatsu, Japan  
April 6, 1965

Dear Sir,

In response to your request for the details of the Unidentified Flying Object which encountered two planes over the Seto Inland Sea, Japan, on March 18, 1965, herein we send you our report based on the information we could collect on the incident.

One of the Convair-240 liners of the Toa Air Lines, JA 5131, which took off from Osaka International Airport for Hiroshima, was flying west over the Ieshima Islands (3440N, 13430E) at an altitude of 6000 feet at 1005 GMT, when its captain pilot, Yoshiharu Inaba, 43, suddenly noticed some unidentified but luminescent object approaching his plane. He is a career pilot with an experience of 8600 flight hours. The flight visibility around there at that time was more than 25 miles with the bright full moon in the cloudless sky. The pilot discovered it 60 degrees left to his course. The altitude was estimated at 7000 feet or somewhat more. Moving from west to east, it seemed to descend toward him. The captain called copilot Majima's attention to it and, maintaining the same course and altitude, blinked the taxi lights for a warning as it threatened to come too close to the passenger plane. And yet the brilliant thing continued to rapidly approach it. The object looked like an equilateral triangle with a side of about 50 feet and radiated a greenish light from its center. The pilot was shocked to see it dangerously near, made a 60-degree turn to the right to avoid the collision. At the moment the UFO made an abrupt turn and flew along with or chased the plane for about three minutes. Meanwhile the ADF indicators vibrated violently; the plane began pitching a little. The weather was just fine as it had been. The pilot tried immediately to contact his company or the Osaka air traffic control tower about the situation over the radio, but in vain. Strangely enough, the UFO disappeared all of a sudden at 1009 GMT. At 1014 GMT the pilot reported the incident to the Takamatsu tower which was the first station he could contact.

Another plane in flight, JA 3231, a Piper Apache of the Tokyo Airlines, monitoring this radio message, told the tower that he had also seen such a luminous object at 1007 GMT about 10 Miles east of Takamatsu City (3417N), (13404E). And the two planes talked with each other over the mysterious thing they had encountered on the radio for a few minutes, which was all recorded into the tower tape recorder. According to Mr. Negishi the pilot of the Piper Apache, the altitude of the UFO was about 9000 feet when he found it near on his way back to Osaka International Airport at an altitude of 7500 feet.

Just about the same time on the same day, some civil engineers working in a mountain in Hiroshima Prefecture were said to have seen what appeared to be a flying saucer. Besides, a policeman and his wife were reported to have seen such an object in Tokushima Prefecture, Shikoku Island.

This is about all concerning our Flying Saucer Incident. Nobody knows what it actually was. We are getting a number of inquiries on it from interested quarters at home and abroad. We are also very interested in the study of this kind of events. Any information you could provide us would be appreciated.

### L I G H T S I N T H E S K Y W E R E M E T E O R S

Explanation of the lighted bodies in the sky last Sunday night.....

"As reported in the newspaper "Berlingske Times" yesterday, many people were frightened when they saw half a dozen "fire-balls" pass across the sky from south toward north Sunday past midnight. The paper explained that it was probably meteors, and this theory was supported by the astronomical observer Axel V. Nielsen of Ole Romer Observatory in Aarhus who said: It could have been several fireballs following one fireball from which they originated by disintegration in the atmosphere. A good example of this was seen in 1954 when a large fireball which divided itself into three separate fireballs rushed across the sky 60 Klmts. up.

Observer Axel V. Nielsen said that he would be very interested in any reliable information about the phenomena last Sunday night...particularly regarding the course in relationship to the stars so that one could calculate height and... direction of movement."

An Eyewitness Account....."A formation of I2-I4 unknown bodies, each with a long fire tail passed over my head in a great height coming from South-Southeast toward N. Northeast with no sound. In my long life I have never seen the likes of it. It appeared that the lighted bodies were guided on a definite course and suddenly rejoined the formation again. They stayed at the same height as long as I could see them. I have seen meteors before but they always went in a curve and were extinguished in front of my eyes.

Observer Nielsen has said that it could be fireballs or one fireball disintegrating in the atmosphere. The light intensity and length of the tails were the same for them all and the way the formation moved indicated to me, flying bodies under control. It will interest me, and others, to hear if anyone else has seen such a phenomena,"

Berlingske Times - April 12, 1965 - I T W A S N O T M E T E O R S

An American satellite burned up in the atmosphere over Denmark on 4/5/65.....

"It appears, that the people who doubted that the lights in the sky during the evening of April 5th were meteors, were right in doubting such. We have been informed that an American satellite burned up over Scandinavia at that time. Many people at 0:28 O'clock saw half a dozen fireballs passing from horizon to horizon SSE to NNW. The passage lasted about 45 seconds.

Observer Nielsen, who did not see the phenomenon said, there couldn't be much doubt about it., it was meteors. The ones who saw the phenomenon disagreed..... The newspaper's artist, Otto C., who several times has seen meteors was convinced that they could not be that. He said...I have never seen anything like it, and, will never forget it."
